4★ ARIZONA over Kansas - First mtg since 1966. Kansas has lost 15 straight gms before bye (2-13 ATS). Jayhawks 1 win from bowl-eligibility but trending in wrong direction. They've lost 2 of last 3 and were only +26yds last wk vs 1-8 Oklahoma St. Kansas also 0-4 SU & ATS vs 4 best opponents. Their pass eff D ranks 96th with an 11-4 ratio which will get exposed this wk in Tucson. Arizona is 5-3 and coming off a 52-17 road rout of Colorado. After b2b road trips, they're back home where they're 4-1 with the only loss to 8-0 BYU by 6. QB Noah Fifita will improve his 21-4 ratio at the expense of the suspect KU secondary. Arizona is the hotter team with the better D and they'll handle Kansas by over 2 td's for our Top Newsletter play this week!

FORECAST: ARIZONA by 17

3★ NORTH CAROLINA over Stanford - Former NFL HC's Bill Belichick and Frank Reich meet for the fourth time and first as College HC's. Belichick's Pat's were 2-1 vs Reich's Colts and the home team was 3-0 SU/ATS. Stanford has lost their two trips to the ETZ by 28 at Virginia and 35 at Miami. They are -14 ppg/-138 ypg in ACC play. NC is two plays away from a 3 game winning streak. They fumbled at the goal line at Cal and lost to Virginia in OT despite a 353-259 yd edge. LW they were +1' at Syracuse and had a 425-147 yd edge in a 27-10 win. The Heels D is allowing 321 ypg and holding foes 58 ypg below their avg. They covered in their only two games as favorites this year. Stanford QB Ben Gulbranson has a 9-10 ratio and Stanford's Oline is among the worst in the ACC, avg 81 rush ypg (2.5) and they've allowed 29 sacks. NC shuts down another weak offense and this is a team we will continue to play on!

FORECAST: NORTH CAROLINA by 20

3★ UCONN (+) over Duke - Duke has won the last two meetings though LW they were -16' and UConn led 21-17 4Q. Duke hit a 47 yd fg then a td to lead 26-21. UConn missed a 47 yd fg then Duke ran the last 5:42 out. HC Jim Mora is 8-3-1 ATS vs the ACC here. The Huskis already beat BC on the road and nearly upset Syracuse before QB Angeli was hurt. Duke is 5-3 SU/4-4 ATS. LW they trailed Clemson 45-38 but the refs missed an offensive PI then Duke scored and got the 2 pt for a 46-45 upset. This is a massive sandwich for Duke with Virginia on deck. This is a battle of two QB's who rarely turn the ball over. Duke's Mensah has a 21-2 ratio while UConn's Fagnano has a 22-0 ratio! Duke is #113 in our pass D rankings (69%, 8-8). UConn is #76 in our Pass D Rankings (63%, 11-8). Mora is 14-7 ATS at home here. We won a 3★ LPS on UConn when they were in a great situation and beat BC a few weeks ago so it makes sense to go back to them with another great situation here!

2★ San Diego St over Hawaii - SD St has won 5 straight and 11 of last 13 mtgs. With Boise St's loss to Fresno last wk, Aztecs are the last MWC tm without a conf loss. They're 7-1 with 6 straight wins behind one of the nation's toughest defenses. SD St only allows 10ppg and is #11 in run D and #10 in pass eff D holding opp to 50.6 completion %. The offense averages 29ppg but it hasn't had to be potent for the team to rise to the top of the league. Hawaii's title hopes took a big hit with last wk's 45-38 loss at San Jose St. Warriors had won 3 straight before the loss. Hawaii 4-1 SU & ATS and has scored at least 31 pts in 4 straight gms. While UH holds opp 7ypg below their average (#66 FBS), 3 of the last 4 opp gained more than 400 yds. And they gave up ssn-high 630 yds in the loss to the Spartans last wk. We've won 2★'s on the Aztecs each of the last two weeks and while it isn't easy to win on the Islands, this SDSU team is on a roll and we are riding a streak.

FORECAST: San Diego St by 13

2★ SAN JOSE ST over Air Force - SJSt has upset Air Force in 2 of last 3 mtgs including last yr, 17-7, as 3pt dog. HC Niumatalolo spent more than 2 decades at Navy and knows how to defend the option. Plus, run D ranks #3 in MWC at 123ypg and 3.7ypc. Falcons were favored in first 8 mtgs. At 2-6, AF is in danger of missing bowls in b2b years. They outplayed Army last wk but lost 20-17. The offense gains 88ypg above opp avg (#20 FBS) but failed to reach 400 yds in the last 2 gms. The defense allows 89ypg more than opp avg (#127 FBS) and the pass D is dead-last in the FBS with 15-4 ratio. Spartans 3-5 with 3 straight home wins. They're led by QB Walker Eget who has a 17-3 ratio and Danny Scudero, the nation's only 1,000-yd WR. In last wk's 45-38 Hawaii win, Spartans had ssn-high 630yds and ssn-high AGG of 105.2. SJ St's knack for run-stuffing and Air Force's inability to stop the pass make this a very favorable matchup for the home team!

Wednesday November 5th

Kent St by 3 over BALL ST - Cardinals are 5-1 SU but 3-3 ATS vs Flashes s/13. Despite kent St facing a much tougher schedule (#67 #99). Both teams come in 3-5 SU & 5-3 ATS and are 2-2 SU in MAC play but Ball St is 2-1 ATS in MAC play while KSU is 3-1 ATS. With no common foes in MAC play: Ball St is being outscored by an avg 26-17 & outgained by 128 ypg. Kent St has an avg 26-26 score being outgained by 100 ypg. In their last games: Ball St (-6) lost at NIU 21-7 (7-7 HT) being outgained 370-275. Kent St (+8) beat BG 24-21 but were outgained by 85 yds. In their only other game as a Favorite Ball St (-3) just got by FCS New Hampshire 34-29 with a 22 yd edge. Ball St QB Kiae Kelly is throwing for 123 ypg (57 %) with a 6-5 ratio but is their #2 rusher (417, 3.0, 5 td). Kent St QB Dru Shields is throwing for 158 ypg (57%) with an 11-2 ratio nd is #4 rusher (41, 1.1, 2 td). KSU Interim HC Mark Carney had that interim tag removed which should give Kent St a boost here, so take the points and the Flashes won 2 of L/3 & covered 3 of L/4.

TOLEDO by 21 over Northern Illinois - UT has won L/3 mtg but are 1-2 ATS. This game not only determined the MAC West Champ but the MAC Champion as NIU has played in the Most MAC Title games (9) & has also won the most (5, tied with Marshall) while Toledo is 2nd w/8 gm & tied with Miami with 4 wins. TY NIU's last before moving to the MWC has been a disappointment. NIU is 2-6 SU & ATS & just 1-3 SU & ATS in MAC play needing to win out to become bowl eligible. Toledo is 4-4 SU & 5-3 ATS & just 2-2 SU & ATS in MAC play. While they only 2 wins to make a bowl they would need to win out & get lots of help to make the MAC Championship.. After missing 2 gms, NIU QB Josh Hoist the L/2 has avg'd 114 ypg (68%) w/3-1 ratio & comb 84 yd rush with NIU putting up ssn high 21 pts in each and NIU's defense is allowing just 22 ppg for the ssn. LW vs Ball St was tied 7-7 at HT before NIU (+6) pulled away for their only MAC win, 21-7. In UT's MAC conf losses UT blew 13-0 lead over WM & a 21-0 lead over BG but in their 2 wins were by a comb 77 pts. Toledo is also 4-0 SU & ATS in the Glass Bowl, so fly with the Rockets.

Thursday November 6th

USF by 14 over Utsa - UTSA won the only prior meeting in '23 49-21 (-16) but that was in San Antonio where the Roadrunners have won 24 straight conference games under HC Jeff Traylor. Last week UTSA was +6 at home vs Tulane on Friday night and they led 31-6 2Q and won 48-26. QB McCown hit 31 of 33 for 370 and 4 td's. USF is fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they led Memphis 24-14 w/a 349-121 yd edge at half. They were up 31-17 4Q but gave up a GW td with 1:07 left. The Bulls are 4-0 SU/ATS and +189 ypg at home. UTSA is 1-3 SU/ATS and are -87 ypg on the road. They've lost 7 straight conf road games and are on a 2-7 ATS run as AD. USF is the better team, with the edge in all 3 phases and the home/road splits heavily favor the Bulls.

APPALACHIAN ST by 10 over Georgia Southern - "Deeper Than Hate" has been played every yr since 1993. Home tm has won 4 straight in rivalry. App St has been streaky all yr. After opening 2-0,

they lost 2 on the road, rallied for b2b wins, but lost 2 before the break and sit at 4-4. Mountaineers need 2 wins to avoid b2b bowl-less seasons for first time since joining FBS. Run D is a strength, allowing 3.4 ypc, but pass D ranks 77th with 17-9 ratio. AppSt +40ypg while GaSo -108ypg but Eagles have played tougher slate (#93 vs #124). At 3-5, Eagles need this win. They're 0-4 SU & ATS on road, but losses were to Fresno, USC and JMU. In those gms, they were outscored 43-17 and -274ypg! GS has just 4 sacks vs FBS which will afford time to AppSt QB AJ Swann who returned from injury vs ODU and led 2 late scoring drives. AppSt is 55-10 in Boone last 10 years. With the QB situation improving and GS allowing 5.8ypc, App St opens up the offense and wins at home.

Friday November 7th

Houston by 4 over UCF - Former American rivals meet for 2nd time as Big 12 foes. UCF (-14) won 27-13 in '23. Home tm 0-7-1 ATS since '09. Both tms looking to rebound from bad losses. Houston was stunned at home by WVU which had lost 5 straight. The D could not make stops and Neers pulled away, 45-35. Cougars were outtrushed by 164yds. Houston has been a better road tm at 4-0 & 3-1 ATS and outgaining opp by 86ypg. At 4-4 with trips to TT and BYU left, this is a must-win if UCF wants to bowl. Knights coming off worst gm of '25, a 30-3 loss at Baylor in which they were outgained 417-225. It was fewest yds Baylor has allowed to an FBS tm. UCF was 1-of-11 on 3rd down and had 1 play of 20+yds. The offense needs a spark but D is holding opp 72ypg below their avg (#27 FBS). Knights 4-1 SU & 3-2 ATS in Orlando. After getting embarrassed, Houston will play with purpose, especially on D. In a low-scoring gm, Cougars rebound with close win.

MEMPHIS by 14 over Tulane - Tulane covered 4 straight meetings from '20-'24 but LY Memphis pulled the upset, 34-24 (+14) w/a 454-374 yd edge. If Memphis wins out they will get the G5 Playoff bid. The Tigers only loss was to UAB when QB Lewis was out and they were caught looking ahead to USF. The Tigers handled Rice on the road LW 38-14 (-14). They are 4-0 SU/ATS and +72 ypg at home this year. Tulane is 6-2 SU/4-4 ATS but LW they were dominated at UTSA in 48-26 (-6). QB Retzlaff has only thrown 6 td passes and Tulane remains last in the AAC, converting just 17 of 34 trips into td's. QB Lewis is a dual threat (470, 4.8) but was banged up again last week. Tulane is rushing for 175 (4.9) and Memphis did give up 219 and 295 in the last 2 weeks. We can't help but like the home team here as Tulane has struggled on the road.

USC by 20 over Northwestern - Wildcats 0-5 all-time vs USC. Teams last met in '96 Rose Bowl won by Trojans, 41-32. NW's first trip to Coliseum since '69. NW is 5-3 SU and 6-2 ATS with an upset road win over Penn St that got the HC fired. They have a solid run game at 188 ypg, led by Komolafe (608, 4.9). The D is holding foes to 74 ypg below their average. In their last game they lost by 7 at Nebraska despite a 331-296 yd edge. USC opened 5-2 with a 2-pt loss at Illinois and 10-pt loss at ND. LW they were at the same Nebraska team and USC won, 21-17 (-4). USC is 4-0 SU at home, winning by 33 ppg and +278 ypg. QB Maiava is hitting 65% with a 15-5 ratio and the D is holding foes to 25 ypg below their average. NW is 1-2 on the road and -9 ppg and -47 ypg. USC 6-1 ATS as a HF the last 2 yrs and the Trojans have too much offense for the Wildcats.

Saturday November 8th

EAST CAROLINA by 35 over Charlotte - EC is out for revenge for LY's 55-24 beatdown when they were -9. Tim Albina's tenure at CLT has gotten off to a rocky start. The 49ers are 1-7 SU/2-6 ATS and -153 ypg. Their only win was against FCS Monmouth and against FBS foes they are -24 ppg and -189 ypg. EC just blasted Temple 45-14 (-5). They put up a season high 614 yards including 358 rush! The Pirates are 3-1 in American play and they have a huge game vs Memphis on deck. Their D is allowing 17ppg/326 ypg while their offense is putting up 90 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. CLT just lost 54-20 vs North Texas prior to their bye, though that game was actually tied at halftime. They were outgained 375-121 in the 2H. The 49ers D is allowing 478 ypg and 103 ypg more than their foes avg. This is a sandwich spot for EC and a potential let down but we can't back Charlotte right now.

FAU by 7 over Tulsa - FAU has won 3 of 4 recent meetings (3-0-1 ATS). These two met in the ssn finally LY. FAU led 42-9 at half and won 63-16 but both have new coaches now. The Owls are 3-5 SU/4-4 ATS and +19 ypg. They are off B2B road losses to USF and Navy. They beat UAB at home by 20 this year and had a misleading loss to Memphis where they trailed 31-26 4Q then allowed 24 points in the last 10 minutes. Tulsa has lost 4 straight but prior to their bye they were +5' and only lost 38-37 in OT when they missed a 2 pt conv. QB Baylor Hayes has a 9-3 ratio. FAU plays 3 of their L/4 at home so this is a must win for bowl hopes. FAU has the edge in all 3 phases so we are giving the home team a 7 point spread.

Florida by 3 over KENTUCKY - FL owned this series, winning 31 straight from 1987-2017. KY actually won 3 straight for the first time since '48-'51 then the Gators won LY 48-20. KY kept their bowl hopes alive by beating Auburn LW 10-3 (+11). The 'Cats are -29 ypg vs the SEC and their D is holding foes 39 ypg below their avg. FL was outgained 361-281 last week but covered vs Georgia, losing 24-20 (+7). The Gators D is allowing just 21 ppg and holds foes 47 ypg below their avg. Florida is 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS and -83 ypg away from home but KY is 0-3 SU/1-2 ATS at home vs the SEC though they did outplay Texas with a 395-179 yd edge yet lost 16-13 then put up 476 yards but lost to Tenn by 22. 'Cats will keep this closer than expected but they've lost 10 straight SEC home games.

James Madison by 14 over MARSHALL - Last 3 mtgs, home team 0-3 SU & ATS. Marshall won LY, 35-33, in double OT so JMU will be out for revenge. Dukes are the heavy fav to win the SBC. They're 7-1 and 5-0 in conf, winning SBC gms by an average of 38-16 and +202ypg. In their last 2, JMU hammered ODU & Texas St by combined score of 115-47. The D holds opp 147 ypg below avg (#2 FBS) and the offense is heating up around QB Alonza Barrett (11 tot td's last 2 gms). Marshall was humbling along with 4 wins in 5 gms and leading Coastal Carolina, 27-17, before collapsing in 2H of 44-27 loss. Herd returns home where they've won 3 straight SU & ATS. However, they're -2 ypg at home and D allows opp 81 ypg over their average (#125 FBS). Marshall is dangerous at home and 7-3 ATS as a HD since '17 (2-0 this yr). But JMU is playing at an entirely different level on both sides of the ball. Dukes will wear out the Herd defense in 2-td win.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 9 Georgia St - Last 4 trips to Coastal, Georgia St 4-0 SU & ATS with 3 outright upsets. Home tm 0-8 SU & 0-7-1 ATS all-time in series! Without much warning, CCU one of SBC's hottest tms. After hitting rock bottom with 40pt loss to ODU, Chants have won 3 straight wins and 2nd place in the East. It hasn't been pretty and tm is -93ypg but they've found ways to win after HT and get to 5-3. Last wk they fell behind Marshall before roaring back with final 27pts to win 44-27. D only allows 18ppg at home and leads SBC in RZ stops. Georgia St comes out of bye 1-7 with 5 straight losses. They're 0-3 SU & ATS on the road. Panthers -24ypg in SBC gms incl 7pt loss to JMU (-20), outgaining GaSo & 7pt loss to USA. QB Cameran Brown has been a bright spot with 12-1 ratio and 275 rushing. GS has been plucky and hasn't quit on this ssn. But Coastal has momentum and is the much better 2H tm (+22pts vs -107pts).

WEST VIRGINIA by 11 over Colorado - First mtg since '09. Tms enter Week 11 on opposite ends of the momentum spectrum. WVU just shocked Houston, 45-35, snapping a 5gm losing streak in their best road effort of the yr. The offense may be finding a QB in true frosh Scotty Fox who accounted for 222 yds and 3 td's. Neers have covered 3 of last 4 and only lost by 6 and were -1 yd to TCU (-16) wk before Houston upset. Meanwhile, the wheels have come off Colorado. The 3-6 Buffs have lost b2b gms to Utah and Arizona by combined score of 105-24. The defense ranks #134 against the run and the offense averages just 19ppg vs P4 opp. Now fading Colorado must make its longest road trip of the yr to face a team whose confidence is rising. Coach Sanders appears to have lost his tm while Rich Rod will look to build a head of steam into '26. The trends will continue for both of these schools as WVU keeps Colorado reeling with DD win.

Smu by 17 over BOSTON COLLEGE - This is BC's Red Bandana game. LY SMU was -18 and fresh off a bye but only won 38-28. LW they were off an upset loss at Wake Forest and +10' vs Miami. SMU never trailed by more than 7 and won 26-20 in OT. BC has lost 8 straight and they are -144 ypg. BC switched to QB Grayson James and only lost by 14 at L'ville. LW they were +30 vs Notre Dame but went back to QB Loneragan but he was benched early and James threw for 240 (1 td, 2 int's) as they only lost 25-10. Their D is allowing 59 ypg more than their foes avg. This is SMU's first trip to the Northeast in November. James has a ratio and faces an SMU D that is allowing 300 pass ypg but is #25 in our pass D rankings (58%, 18-14). SMU has a bye on deck then a huge game vs Louisville. BC has been more competitive so we are leaning with the dog here.

Florida St by 1 over CLEMSON - These two were expected to contend for an ACC Title but now both are just fighting for bowl eligibility. FSU is off their best showing since beating Bama. They were off a 4 game losing streak then crushed Wake Forest 42-7 (-10) w/a 421-247 yd edge. Clemson got QB Klubnik back and he threw for 385 yards and 2 td's but the D continues to be an issue and they lost to Duke 46-45 (-3) in OT. The Tigers are allowing 24 ppg and 351 ypg. FSU avg 40 ppg/511 ypg and they put up 143 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. LY Clemson had a 500-250 yd edge but settled for 7 fg's and missed 2, costing their backers a cover (-16'). FSU is still playing hard for Norvell and a win here could spark a 5 game win streak with a light closing schedule. We are calling for FSU to hand Clemson yet another loss.

LOUISVILLE by 14 over California - First meeting. Cal is still searching for their 6th win after B2B losses. The Bears offense has put up just 292 ypg including 42 rush ypg (1.4) in their L/4 games. QB JKS only has a 5-8 ratio in their last 6 games. UL is among 6 teams with a shot at the ACC title game. The Cardinals are 7-1 but didn't cover 2 weeks ago vs BC in a 38-24 (-25') win then LW they trailed for most of the game at VTech but a late 24 yd td run by BR Brown gave Cardinals backers a cover. All-ACC RB Isaac Brown (782, 8.6) is out for this game. QB Miller Moss only has an 11-6 ratio. Cal's two recent losses were by 8 and 10 points. Justin Wilcox is 21-12 as a road dog while UL is 0-5 as a home favorite this year. Louisville has Clemson and SMU the next two weeks. Cal has either won or been within a td in all 5 trips to the ETZ as an ACC member but are getting 18' points here so we like the dog.

MIAMI, FL by 34 over Syracuse - Massive revenge spot for Miami. The 'Canes were -11 LY in the season finale. Miami had a 503-479 yd edge but lost 42-38 which cost them a playoff spot. Miami is coming off a loss to SMU but they did have a 433-388 yd edge. The 'Canes D is holding foes to 285 ypg and 134 ypg below their avg (#4 in FBS). Cuse QB's Filardi (Walk-On) and Carney (true frosh) combined for 4-18 for 39 yards LW. The Orange lost at home to North Carolina 27-10, outgained 425-147. Syracuse has lost their last 5 by 21 ppg and they are -121 ypg in ACC play. Miami is +22 ppg/+173 ypg at home. The 'Canes are angry off a loss with revenge on their mind. The D will suffocate whoever Syracuse throws out at QB so we will lay over 4 td's.

Indiana by 24 over PENN ST - Indiana 2-25 all-time (wins '13 & '20) vs Penn St & 0-13 SU (6-7 ATS) in Happy Valley but come in heavily favored. Last time here, Indy (+31') lost 33-24. PSU is 0-5 ATS at home this year. This was expected to be a major showdown & Indiana has held up its end of the bargain, opening a dominating 8-0 SU & 5-3 ATS, winning by an avg of 45-11 and +252 ypg. LW, Indiana dismantled host Maryland, 55-10 (-21'). Penn St was expected to contend for a national title, starting off 3-0 & led Oregon in OT but lost. The season came crashing down, losing to UCLA & Northwestern, & started fired HC Franklin. QB Allar is OFY so Grunkemeyer is hitting 63% with a 1-3 ratio & his first 3 games vs Iowa, Ohio St and now Indiana's tough D's. They covered at Iowa in a 1-pt loss. LW, Penn St fell to Ohio St 38-14 (+17'). While Cignetti was 11-2 in his 1st yr, Indy was 0-2 vs ranked teams, losing to Ohio St by 23 and to ND in playoffs. This yr, they routed Illinois, 63-10 & beat Oregon on the road, 30-20. You can always count on Cignetti to add a late td to make a statement so we lean with Indiana.

Ohio St by 33 over PURDUE - OSU has 42-15-2 series edge. S/'00, Bucks just 4-5 SU & 3-6 ATS in West Lafayette. Last time here in '23, OSU (-17') scored first 34 pts in 41-7 win. Since '21 OSU 7-5 ATS when laying 20+ on road. Last 9 at home vs OSU, Purdue 5-4 SU & 6-3 ATS. Overall, Boilers 0-3 ATS last 3 vs Bucks ('21, '23, '24), getting outscored 145-38. LY, Purdue (+37') had just 206 yards in 45-0 home loss. Ohio St lost 14 players to the NFL from LY's National Champ squad but opened 8-0 & 7-1 ATS. LW the Buckeyes got revenge on DC Knowles with a 38-14 win (-17') over Penn St. The Buckeyes D is #1, holding foes to 182 ypg below their average and QB Sayin has remarkable stats hitting 81% with a 23-3 ratio. Purdue has been a much improved team under HC Odom. LY they lost their B10 games by 30 ppg. This yr they are 0-6 in B10 play, but almost beat both Rutgers & Minnesota. LW Purdue covered, but lost at Michigan 21-16 (+21'). Purdue is playing a 6th straight week and just faced physical Michigan LW. Ohio St fans travel well, so should make up a good portion of crowd. Take the Buckeyes to cover.

RUTGERS by 3 over Maryland - Maryland leads series 12-8. Teams met every year since '14. Terps 7-4 SU & ATS. Last time here '23, Terps (-2) never trailed, racked up 498 yds in 42-24 win. Since '07, Rutgers 1-5 SU & ATS at home vs MD (lone win '17, 31-24, as 3' pt dog). In those 6 games, only '19 went under total (48-7 Terps win with 55' total). Road team has covered 5 of last 6. Since Schiano returned Rutgers won in the Covid yr than lost 3 in a row by 24, 37 and 18 before turning the tables last year as a 4'-pt road dog. Maryland opened 4-0 SU with a big road win at Wisconsin but then lost 3 close games in a row leading Washington & Nebraska in 4Q and losing on a last-second FG to UCLA. LW the Terps were dismantled by visiting Indiana 55-10 (+21').

Rutgers opened 3-0 non conf but were 0-4 in B10 play. They did pull out a road win at Purdue. LW Rutgers went on the road & lost to Illinois 35-13 (+13'). Terps are 22-39 ATS vs B10. We see Rutgers winning by 3.

VIRGINIA by 10 over Wake Forest - WF won 5 straight meetings between '08-'21. LY UVA trailed 30-17 4Q, scored td's with 10:37 and 2:07. WF put up 544 yards and reached UVA territory in 10 of 13 drives but were SOD and Fumbled the L/2. UVA remains as the only unbeaten team in ACC play as their loss to NC State was non-conference. The Cavaliers found their stride again offensively last week, putting up 456 yards at Cal and a late Pick-6 earned the cover. They allowed just 263 yards. WF is 5-3 SU/ATS. They had won 3 straight heading into LW but were crushed at Florida St 42-7, outgained 421-247. RB Claiborne was just 14-27 LW and faces a UVA D that allowed 8 rush yards LW. WF QB's Ashford and Purdue combine for a 9-7 ratio and both hit less than 60%. WF's D is holding foes 87 ypg below their avg but UVA has big edges on both offense and ST's. With UVA's offense back on track we like the Cavaliers to win by double-digits.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Bowling Green - Falcons need to win out to make a bowl while EM will miss bowl ssn this year. EM has won L/3 (2-1 ATS) s/'16 but first game since a EM (-3') won 55-24 in '21 but visitor has covered 4 straight. Falcons are 1-4 SU & ATS in MAC play with their only win being vs rival Toledo a game they trailed 21-0 but won 28-23 thanks to 45 & 73 yd td passes and a 1 yd GW td "drive" after a FR and were still outgained 429-226. BG is being outscored by 11 ppg & outgained by 48 ypg in conf play. EM is also 1-4 SU but 3-2 ATS in MAC play. EM is being outscored by 5 ppg & outgained 71 ypg. Both lost to UB & CM: BG (0-2 ATS) lost to UB by 25 & CM by 21, while EM lost to UB by 1 & CM by 11. BG has Def edge (#97-#128), while EM has Off edge (#98-#131). Eagles are 3-0 ATS at home vs FBS while Falcons are 2-2 ATS on the road. This will be a tight game that could go either way but BG is on an 0-3 SU & ATS streak.

Georgia by 7 over MISSISSIPPI ST - LY UGA had a 369-130 yd edge at half but MSU scored 3 2nd half td's and only lost 41-31 (+33'). Georgia has been notoriously slow starters this year. They've only led at half in one SEC game and they trailed at half in wins over Tenn, Aub and Ole Miss along with the loss to Bama. The Dawgs are +63 ypg vs the SEC despite being -27 in the 1H of those games. MSU is 5-4 SU/7-1-1 ATS and are +40 ypg but -72 vs the SEC. However, in Davis Wade Stadium they are +97 ypg and led Texas by 17 4Q (lost in OT), led Tenn by 7 4Q (lost in OT) and upset Arizona St when they were healthy. HC Lebby is 9-4 ATS vs SEC foes. UGA is on a 2-7 ATS run as an AF. Georgia is laying over a td on the road and we expect MSU to play tough at home again and keep it within a td.

LIBERTY by 14 over Missouri St - These two met as FCS foes in 1989 & 1994 and split those meetings. Liberty still has a shot at the CUSA Title game as they've won 3 straight. LW they were -3' against Delaware. They put up ssn highs of 59 points and 561 yards, led by RB Evan Dickens who ran for 217. Now they host the other of CUSA's new editions with MSU who comes in 5-3 SU/ATS and are also on a 3 game win streak. The Bears won both CUSA road games this year but trailed Middle Tenn in the 4Q and needed OT to beat NMST. QB Jacob Clark is hitting 64% w/a 15-7 ratio. Liberty is #31 in our Pass D Rankings (55%, 9-6). Chadwell is 7-2 ATS when favored at home by less than 2 td's and the Flame has lit for this squad as they make a late season run.

Uab by 1 over RICE - This is UAB's 3rd time seeing the triple option this year. They were +21 at Navy and lost 38-24, outgained 463-413 and they had a 362-295 yard edge vs Army but lost 31-13. The Blazers got QB Kitna back last week at UConn but he wasn't 100% and they switched to Ryder Burton who led the upset win over Memphis. UAB trailed 31-0 3Q but scored 3 td's to only lose 38-19 (+11'). Rice upset UConn 2 weeks ago but LW they were held to a ssn low 212 yards and lost 38-14 at home vs Memphis. UAB's DC Steve Russ was DC at Air Force from '12-'17 and was an Asst HC there last year which explains how the Blazers held both Army and Navy below their ssn avg. UAB has played the tougher sked and the matchup favors the road dog so we are calling for an upset here.

TCU by 7 over Iowa St - Home team 4-0-1 ATS last 5 in series. LTH in '22, Cyclones (+10) were -3 TO's in 62-14 loss. Cyclones have been a major disappointment this yr, losing 4 straight after a 5-0 start and #14 poll ranking. Injuries have been a factor, but ASU was without its QB last wk yet found a way to beat ISU in Ames 24-19. Clones' 2 lowest AGGs came in last 3 wks. Iowa St 0-3 ATS on the road, allowing 409 ypg. While this is ISU's 6th straight wk in action, TCU is off a much-needed break. Frogs reached by wk 6-2 SU with road losses to Arizona St and Kansas St. They're 4-0 SU & 3-1 ATS in Fort Worth. Led by QB Josh Hoover (65%, 22-6 ratio) and WR Eric McAlister (727, 19.6), TCU averages 39ppg at home. Both will have big gms vs a depleted secondary and a D that's given up 400+ yds in 3 of the last 4 gms. As Iowa St sinks further, TCU is still eyeing a 10-win ssn. They'll send Cyclones to another loss though gm will be competitive in 2H.

Texas A&M by 12 over MISSOURI - A&M has won & covered the L/2 meetings. A&M beat Miz-zou 41-10 (-2') LY with a 512-254 yard edge. The Aggies are 8-0 SU/4-4 ATS and prior to the bye they crushed LSU 49-25 a 426-278 yard edge. Mizzou's D is allowing 17 ppg/242 ypg and are holding foes 119 ypg below their avg but they've played a weak sked. QB Pribula is OFY so this will be QB Zollers first career start. Zollers played well against Vandy (14-23-138-1-0) and Mizzou had a 376-265 yard edge but lost 17-10. Eli Drinkwitz is 8-3-1 as a home dog while A&M is 3-3 as away favorites. A&M has played a much tougher sked (#5 vs #56). A&M is only laying a td which seems cheap with a defensive HC taking on a frosh QB making his first career start.

TEXAS TECH by 14 over BYU - BYU's first trip to Lubbock since 1940. Cougars (+3) won last mtg in '23, 27-14. These are the 2 Big 12 favs so this could be the first of 2 mtgs. Cougars are league's only unbeaten tm. They have rest advantage but are just 1-5 ATS last 6 off a bye. BYU has been more steady than spectacular, only outgaining opp by 18 ypg on the road. However, the D ranks #8 against the pass (7-12 ratio) and the offense is underrated with dual-threat QB Bear Bachmeier, RB LJ Martin (789, 6.0) and two 500-yd receivers. TT has rebounded from its only loss with b2b blowouts. OklSt was expected but 43-20 at Kansas St (+111yds) showed Red Raiders still Big 12 team to beat. TT ranks #14 in both off ypg above opp avg and holding opp below their avg. They got a big boost from the return of QB Behren Morton who shook off rust and went 21-32-249-2-1. No TT win has been by less than 24pts. BYU is too well coached and too good defensively for things to get that out of control, but they'll fall for the first time this year.

Temple (+) over ARMY - Temple has lost 3 straight vs Army though they did cover LTH, only losing 31-28 (+6). LY Army had a 417-(-5) rush yard edge and won 42-14 (-12). Temple is off a 45-14 (+5) loss to East Carolina where their defense gave up a ssn high 614 yds including 358 on the ground. QB Evan Simon hit just 11 of 20 for 80 yards and finally threw an int but still has a 21-1 ratio. Army is off an option matchup vs Air Force and the Black Knights won 20-17 (+1). Army is rushing for 265 (4.6). Temple's DC Brian Smith was DC at Rice LY and they held Navy to 10 points and 260 yards but Army had 37 points and 408 yards. Temple had Navy beat this year when they led 31-24 but Navy got a 51 yd td run with :39 left and a 2 pt conv to win by 1. Temple had a 518-384 yd edge. Army's offense isn't as explosive as Navy's this year and Temple is getting 6.5 points. This is a must win for Temple, who has 5 wins and Tulane/NTex on deck and we are calling for the upset.

VANDERBILT by 14 over Auburn - LY Auburn had a 327-227 yard edge but Vandy pulled the upset 17-7. Normally we would jump on the Tigers in a revenge spot but Auburn just fired Hugh Freeze and their offense is punchless. They've lost five of their last 6 and LW put up just 3 points and 241 yards. DJ Durkin is the Interim HC. Auburn's D is allowing 310 ypg and holds foes 107 ypg below their avg (#10 in FBS) but their offense has topped 17 points in just 1 of their last six games and the only exception was against Arkansas' awful defense and they even trailed that game until the Hogs got turnover happy. Despite 2 losses Vandy still has playoff aspirations. We are still reeling from their backdoor effort to push LW at Texas when they trailed 34-10. It was 34-24 when Vandy converted a 4th and 19 from their own 1 which led their td with :33 left and ruined our top LPS on Texas -3. Vandy's D is holding foes 22 ypg below their avg and we don't expect the Interim HC bounce to happen this late in the season as Auburn's players contemplate the Portal. Vandy wins by 2 td's.

ALABAMA by 24 over LSU - Bama is 14-4 SU/11-7 ATS and the home team is 2-7 ATS in this series. This will be LSU's first game under Interim HC Frank Wilson after Brian Kelly was terminated. LSU started 4-0 but they've lost 3 of their L/4 and their last loss was a 49-25 whoopin at home vs Texas A&M. LSU's top RB Caden Durham has just 378 (4.8) and their top WR Aaron Anderson has 382 (13.2) with both missing time with injuries. Since the loss to FSU, Bama has won 7 straight and are +98 ypg but only +29 vs the SEC. Their D is allowing 313 ypg and holding foes 99 ypg below their avg. Ty Simpson has a 20-1 ratio. Bama's SEC wins haven't been very convincing but they are 26-9-1 ATS as a home favorite and LSU looks like a dumpster fire. Tide are -10 and we are calling for a dominant win for the home team.

LOUISIANA by 5 over Texas St - Louisiana 12-0 SU & 11-1 ATS all-time vs Texas St. Cajuns (+4) won last yr on road, 23-17. Louisiana coming off one its best AGGs of the year (99.1), beating USA on the road, 31-22. Cajuns led 45-7 at HT and extended to 31-7 in 3Q. QB Lunch Winfield had his best gm (14-15-232-2-0 and 24-1 rush). A week earlier, they outgained Troy 371-345 and the defense has held 3 straight opp below 400 yds. Cajuns +23pyg at home. Texas St coming off much-needed bye. Bobcats have lost 4 straight and 5 in a row ATS. The one-time SBC contenders are 1-3 ATS away from home. They dropped 3 straight 1-score gms to Arkansas St, Troy, and Marshall before getting routed by JMU (TexSt's worst AGG of yr). Bobcats do have best unit here. Their offense averages 34ppg and 120pyg above opp avg (#11 FBS). QB Brad Jackson has 17 tot td's. With history and momentum on its side, Louisiana survives a tight shootout.

Oregon by 3 over IOWA - Ducks making first trip to Iowa since '89 (won 44-6 as 3-pt dog). Off bye, Oregon is 8-2 SU & 5-4-1 ATS over last 10. Since '21, Ducks have made 6 regular season trips to Central time zone (6-0 SU/4-2 ATS). First meeting in 31 years. Hawkeyes 1-7 ATS last 7 vs ranked opp's but did cover vs Indiana at home this year. Since '19, Iowa 4-4 SU & ATS off bye week and shut out Wisconsin this year. Oregon is 7-1 with a big road win in a White Out at Penn St in OT but did lose at home to Indiana by 10. Iowa is 6-2 with a 3-pt loss at Iowa St and a 5-pt home loss to Indiana. QB Gronowski is hitting 68% with a 1-3 ratio and has rushed for 225 (5.2) w/ 8 TDs. The D is holding foes to 134 ypg below their average. Oregon 19-13-2 ATS as a HD with Lanning, 11-3 ATS as an AF. Iowa is 6-1 ATS this yr & 8-1 ATS as a single-digit B10 dog. Iowa grinds this game down and keeps it close in Kinick.

Washington by 10 over WISCONSIN - Huskies have won all 4 meetings ('60 Rose Bowl, '67, '68, '92). First trip to Madison since '68 (Huskies won, 21-17). Washington has dropped 8 straight ATS week after bye (0-2 ATS LY vs Indiana/Oregon). Last 5 years off bye, Badgers 3-4 SU & ATS. Fisch is 2-6 SU & 2-6 ATS on the road here. Washington is a legitimate playoff contender with losses to Ohio St & Michigan. They are 6-2 SU and blasted Illinois 42-25 at home in their last game. They have a potent offense with QB Williams (64%, 14-4), RB Jonah Coleman (643, 5.1) and WR Denzel Boston (668, 15.2). Wisconsin is facing the nations toughest schedule and is just 2-6 and down to a #3 QB and numerous other starters are out. They did lose at Oregon 21-7 finally scoring a TD after going 14 quarters without one including B2B shutouts by Iowa and Ohio St. Wisconsin is underrated after playing the toughest 4-gm stretch in the country in October, then having a bye last week to get healthy and rested. It's the #1 schedule strength (Wisc) vs. #30 (Wash). We see the Huskies by 10.

Unlv by 4 over COLORADO ST - Last 7 gms at Colorado St, UNLV 0-7 SU & ATS. Rebels will need to buck that trend to shift its current course. After starting 6-0, they lost b2b to Boise and New Mexico and have allowed at least 40pts and 500yds in 3 straight gms. They were favored vs the Lobos but allowed 2 80-yd td's in 40-35 loss. The D allows foes 90pyg above their avg (#128 FBS) but the offense has yet to be held under 30pts and keeps UNLV in every game. Colorado St is on a 6-0 ATS tear off bye wks (lost to UTSA, 17-16, as 4-pt dog in Wk 4). Rams 2-6 with wins over N. Colorado and Fresno, and fired HC Norvell after Hawaii loss. Offense next to last in MWC scoring (19.1) and ypg (329). D allows opp to gain 64pyg above their avg (#120 FBS). Both tms headed in the wrong direction, but UNLV has the superior backfield with QB Anthony Colandrea (12-4 ratio) and RB Jai'Den Thomas (613, 7.3). Rebels get back to winning with 4pt road victory.

Louisiana Tech by 10 over DELAWARE - These two met once, back in 1982. LT is 5-3 SU/6-2 ATS. LW they put up a season high 55 points and 646 yards against Sam Houston. They rushed for 425 (10.9) with both RB's Thevenin and Wiggins going over 100 yards. Delaware is 4-4 SU and are on an 0-4 ATS run. LW they trailed 28-9 at half and lost 59-30 at Liberty. Delaware is allowing 26 ypg more than their foes avg. LT's offense is much better with Blake Baker at QB. They've scored 30+ in four of his six starts and he threw for 340 vs WKU. Teams that move up to the FCS tend to wear down late in the season as they don't have depth. Delaware seems to fit that bill and we expect LA Tech to win by double-digits.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 3 over Fiu - MT lost 5 straight meetings from '19-'23. FIU won last

year 35-24 (-9). The home team is 10-2 ATS. MT is 1-7 SU/3-5 ATS but are only -45 ypg and +29 ypg vs CUSA. FIU is 3-5 SU/4-4 ATS but only -25 ypg and +25 ypg vs CUSA. FIU QB Jenkins was injured LW so Holy Cross transfer Joe Pesansky could be the starter here. MT's Nicholas Vattiato has a 13-6 ratio but is on thin ice himself. FIU has played the tougher schedule while MT has the edge in ST's and they are at home. Hard to choose a side so we will just give the home team a 3 point edge.

Jacksonville St by 1 over UTEP - Jax St won the only prior meeting 17-14 (+1) in '23. The Gamecocks are 4-0 in CUSA play but only +10 ypg in those. LW they trailed Middle Tenn late 4Q but won 24-21. The Gamecocks rush for 260 ypg (5.4) but UTEP is allowing 155 (3.6) and is #6 in the FBS with 7.8 tfl's per game. The Miners D is holding foes 19 ypg below their avg. Jax St has won 3 straight while UTEP is only 2-6 SU/3-5 ATS. Last week they led Kennesaw 20-16 late 3Q LW but lost 33-20 (+9). UTEP's offense avg just 21 ppg/325 ypg and is putting up 102 ypg less than their foes allow on avg (#131 in FBS). We would like UTEP to win but they just find ways to lose games so we will put this right at the line instead.

Nebraska by 4 over UCLA - Huskers 1st trip to Pasadena since '12 (lost 36-30 as 5-pt dog). Last 4 meetings between teams have been upsets, including LY in Lincoln. Nebraska fell short, 27-20, as 7-pt favorite at home. Bruins 3-0 SU & ATS in last 3 reg szn games vs Nebraska ('12, '13 & '24). Coming out of bye week, Bruins 7-2-1 to the over since '15. UCLA opened 0-3 and after a 35-10 loss to New Mexico they fired HC Foster. They trailed Northwestern 17-0 at half but rallied back to 17-14 with interim HC Skipper then upset Penn St, Mich St and Maryland with Neuheisel calling the plays. Nebraska opened 6-2 with a close 3-pt loss to Michigan and a 24-6 beat-down at Minnesota. They had close wins and were just 3-5 ATS and -21 ypg in B10 play. LW Nebraska lost to USC, 21-17 (+4), & lost QB Raiola for ROY. Nice schedule edge for UCLA as they are off a bye and Nebraska is playing a 6th straight week. Nebraska is playing with legitimate revenge and Husker fans will travel to the Rose Bowl, so the crowd could be in their favor. Even though Vegas favors the Bruins by 2, we lean toward the Huskers by 4.

Southern Miss by 4 over ARKANSAS ST - Southern Miss 0-3 ATS vs Arkansas St since joining SBC but new HC Huff beat Red Wolves, 35-21, while at Marshall in '23. Eagles exit bye 6-2, winners of 4 straight and atop the SBC West. They have the better QB in Braylon Braxton who has an 18-4 ratio. And while the D has allowed 200+ rush yds in 3 of last 4 gms, the pass D ranks 26th with 6-15 ratio. ASU has risen up in the last month with 4 straight wins and can take the division lead with a win here. And after b2b 1-pt wins, Red Wolves beat GA Southern by 10 (+146yds) and then upset Troy on the road to earn sn-high AGG of 104.7. They're 4-0 ATS in Jonesboro and the defense has held 3 straight opp below their ypg average. Southern Miss is the more complete team, and their wins have been more impressive. They'll remain atop the West with a pivotal road win, but ASU has the momentum and homefield edge to keep this close for 60 minutes.

Kennesaw St by 3 over NEW MEXICO ST - First meeting. KSU started 0-2 this year but they've won 6 straight as HC Jerry Mack has to be in the mix for CUSA Coach of the Year. The Owls are -7 ypg vs CUSA. NMST is 3-5 SU/ATS, -89 ypg and -101 vs CUSA. They did beat Sam Houston 37-10 but have lost their last 3 though two of those were by less than a td to Liberty and Missouri St. We can't pick NMST to win the game, but Kennesaw just snapped a 13 game road losing streak two weeks ago and now they are laying nearly double-digits on the road? Aggies have won 3 of their 4 home games so we think they keep it closer than expected.

Utah St by 11 over Nevada - Both tms off bye. Home tm has covered 4 straight & 10-2 ATS since '05. Utah St 4-4 SU & 6-2 ATS needing 2 wins to bowl in HC Mendenhall's first year. At home, Aggies 4-0 SU & ATS and on the road they're 0-4 SU so it's a huge edge being back in Logan. Their wins are by an avg of 39-20 and they're +105 ypg in those gms. The D has been the weak area, allowing 3 of last 4 opp to gain at least 120yds above their avg. Defense less likely to get exposed against Nevada. Nevada 0-4 outside Reno but 3-1 ATS including 1-score losses at Fresno & New Mexico. DE Dylan LaBarbera ranks among nation's leaders in TFLs. Utah St has big edge at QB with Bryson Barnes (21 tot td's). Back home, they'll outscore Nevada by DD.

NOTRE DAME by 35 over Navy - Irish have won 7 straight in series going 4-3 ATS but have covered 4 of L/5 incl L/2. ND has also won & covered L/2 times hosting Navy. LY Irish (-14) led 31-7 HT & up 31-14 3Q pulled away scoring the final 20 pt. Notre Dame after opening with 2 close losses to UM & TX A&M, ND has won L/6 (4-1-1 ATS). LW ND (-30) was SOD twice in BC territory & missed a fg but still won 25-10. Navy opened ssn 7-0 but just 2-5 ATS but LW suffered their first loss of the ssn 31-17 (+6) to North Texas, so could suffer some unbeaten letdown this week. They are still atop the AAC standings and have a big conf game vs USF on deck. While they will not look past ND, if they fall behind they could let the clock run to stay healthy. ND also has one of the biggest schedules edges of the season #8-#128. Irish are back in the top 10 and a big win over a 7-1 team can keep them there. Look for the Irish to take care of business here.

Oregon ST despite playing a much tougher schedule (#51-109) is 2-7 SU & 3-6 ATS losing by an avg 10 ppg. Beavers have won & covered their L/2 and while they have already fired their HC, the team has not quit & after LW upset of Pac 2 foe Washington St 10-7 (+4) the fans rushed the field, so they still have a good home field edge and this is Senior day (FHG). Beavers have the edge on both Off (#100-122) & Def (#75-136) as Sam Houston has only 2 gms with over 21 pts (ssn High 27 vs Jax St) & allowed 35+ pts in all but 1 game (29 vs Jax St). Look for the Beavers to extend their winning streak to 3 straight.

4★ Cleveland over NY JETS - Cleveland projects to control this one on the ground, as the Browns should lean heavily on Quinshon Judkins against a NY JETS defense allowing 135.8 rush YPG and now missing two core defensive pieces after trading away Sauce Gardner and Quinnen Williams. Cleveland still ranks #2 in total defense and carries a consistent pressure rate that has caused issues for Justin Fields in similar matchups, while the Jets enter off a bye where they are 0-4 ATS in their last four seasons. With CLE handing play-calling to Tommy Rees out of the bye, the expectation is a simplified, run-first script that keeps their defense fresh and limits volatility. **Forecast: Cleveland by 14.**

3★ CAROLINA over New Orleans - The Saints continue to freefall, now 1-8 SU and 0-4 ATS in their last four, and the loss of Rashid Shaheed only further limits an offense already averaging just 15.3 PPG. CAROLINA has been far more stable at home and carries a defensive edge here, allowing 22.8 PPG and ranking #13 in total defense compared to New Orleans at #24. This also marks back-to-back road games for the Saints, who have not shown the scoring consistency needed to trade with a Panthers team that has quietly covered 6 of their last 9 and is 5-0 ATS vs NFC opponents. With the Panthers leaning on Rico Dowdle and a controlled, run-first script to keep pressure off Bryce Young, they are positioned to dictate tempo against a tired New Orleans squad. **Forecast: Carolina by 13.**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ LA Rams over SAN FRANCISCO - The Rams come in rolling, winning three straight by two touchdowns or more, and project stronger on both sides of the ball, outgaining opponents for 369.9 YPG (#7) while allowing just 15.9 PPG (#2). SF may again be without Brock Purdy, and if Mac Jones starts, their scoring ceiling remains limited, especially against a Rams defense that has held four of its last five opponents under 20 points. Trends also lean sharply toward Los Angeles, with the 49ers 0-7 ATS after scoring 30+ and the Rams 5-0 ATS after allowing fewer than 15 points in the prior game. Even with SF at home, the matchup and form both favor Los Angeles. Matthew Stafford and the Rams should take care of business and continue to roll here. **Forecast: LA Rams by 10.**

OTHER PLAYS

Las Vegas at DENVER - LV comes in off an overtime loss where TE Brock Bowers was heavily featured (12-127-3), but the offense remains thin after moving on from Jakobi Meyers and continues to struggle running the ball. DEN has leaned on its defense all season, allowing just 18.4 PPG and ranking top-3 in total defense, and they've been notably stronger at home where their pass rush tends to show up. The short week dynamic may lean toward a lower-tempo game, and LV has been inconsistent on the road while DEN has been reliable in this stadium. The matchup likely revolves around whether LV can protect Geno Smith long enough to replicate last week's efficiency, as DEN's defensive front and coverage structure present a very different challenge. ***Get the Thursday Night NFL Marquee online at ncsports.com or call the office at 1-800-654-3448 after 12:00 noon ET. Indianapolis by 10 over Atlanta** - Early Germany Game - IND brings the more complete profile into this neutral-site matchup, leading the league in scoring and top-3 in total offense, and they should be positioned for a bounce-back after moving the ball well last week despite costly turnovers. ATL offense does get stability with Michael Penix healthy, but scoring efficiency has remained inconsistent, and IND's trade for Sauce Gardner adds a matchup tilt - he'll likely draw Drake London, who accounted for the bulk of ATL's explosive production. With the Colts maintaining their balance on the ground and in the air and ATL continuing to struggle to finish drives, the edge leans to IND on the overseas stage.

Buffalo by 10 over MIAMI - BUF comes in off one of their most balanced outings of the season, with QB Josh Allen (23/26, 273 yds, 1 TD) in full command, RB James Cook (27-114) controlling the ground game, and TE Dalton Kincaid (6-101-1) continuing his rise as a primary target. On the other side, MIA again struggled to generate explosive pass plays, with QB Tua Tagovailoa (25/40, 261 yds, 0 TD, 1 INT) working mostly underneath and the offense stalling in scoring situations despite RB De'Von Achane (14-67) providing a spark. BUF has owned this matchup 7 straight SU, and MIAMI is just 1-3 SU/ATS at home vs the Bills in their last four, with Buffalo's defensive structure consistently dictating pace and leverage in these meetings.

HOUSTON by 3 over Jacksonville - This matchup hinges heavily on QB C.J. Stroud's availability, but HOU has been leaning on the league's #1 scoring and total defense (267.4 YPG, 15.1 PPG allowed) to stay competitive regardless of offensive stability. JAX comes off the OT win where QB Trevor Lawrence (23/34, 220 yds) moved the ball efficiently and WR Parker Washington (8-90) stepped up, though the loss of WR Travis Hunter tightens their margin for explosive plays. RB Travis Etienne (22-84) remains the Jaguars' most consistent engine, but JAX is on B2B road, while HOU is B2B home and just held DEN to 216 total yards, with WR Nico Collins (7-75) and TE Dalton Schultz (6-77) both re-emerging as key targets. HOU defensive front has been elite at reducing rushing efficiency and forcing long-drive football, which matches well against a Jacksonville offense that has needed late-game scoring surges to close gaps.

Baltimore by 7 over MINNESOTA - BAL enters off one of their sharpest outings of the season, with QB Lamar Jackson (18/23, 204 yds, 4 TD) efficiently attacking downhill and RB Derrick Henry (19-119, 6.3 YPC) reestablishing the downhill run game in the 28-6 win over MIA. MIN comes in off a tight divisional win, where QB J.J. McCarthy (2 TD pass, 1 rush TD) managed the game well and RB Aaron Jones (9-78) provided the best burst the ground game has shown in weeks. However, MIN is 0-4 ATS following an ATS win, and their defense has recently skewed toward shootouts with the Over 6-0 in their last six. BAL does have B2B road travel, but they hold the more stable offensive identity and matchup edge in early-down efficiency, giving them the upper hand indoors where Lamar's efficiency historically improves.

TAMPA BAY by 3 over New England - TB comes off the bye (Under 5-0 after a bye) and may get WR Chris Godwin back to pair with QB Baker Mayfield, who continues to play MVP level football. NE posted 314 total yards last week (259 pass / 55 rush) behind QB Drake Maye, who threw for 259 yards and 2 TDs while the defense held ATL to just 46 rushing yards, but the Patriots were still sacked 6 times. TB averages 323.0 YPG and 24.6 PPG and should benefit from extra prep and rest, while NE brings 350.7 YPG and 26.3 PPG into this matchup but remains shorthanded if RB Rhamondre Stevenson can't go. NE has covered 5 straight road games, and TB is 6-1 ATS in November games, but with TB's healthier receiving corps and home-field edge, the matchup slightly favors TB in game profiles as a tight game that could swing on pass protection and third-down efficiency.

CHICAGO by 7 over New York Giants - CHI enters off a 47-42 shootout win where QB Caleb Williams threw for 280 yards and 3 TD (114.8 RTG), while RB Kyle Monangai drove the ground game with 176 rushing yards at 6.8 YPC. NYG put up 308 total yards last week (191 pass / 117 rush) with QB Jaxson Dart accounting for 191 yards and 2 TD, but their defense continues to struggle, now allowing 27.7 PPG and ranking #29 in YPG allowed. CHI's offense ranks #3 in the league at 378.4 YPG and has quietly hit 26+ points in six of eight games, while the GIANTS are allowing 30+ in four

straight and are 0-4 ATS after giving up 30+. Both teams trend Over in matchups like this, but the key edge lies in CHI's efficiency passing and Monangai's ability to control tempo against a defense permitting 5.1 YPC over the last month. CHI holds the advantage at home against a NYG defense that has consistently failed to finish stops in the red zone.

SEATTLE by 7 over Arizona - With Kyler Murray sidelined, ARI continues with QB Jacoby Brissett, who threw for 261 yards and 2 TD with a 115.1 rating last week in the win over DAL, while WR Marvin Harrison Jr. added 7 catches for 96 yards and a score. However, SEA has been consistently stronger, ranking #9 in total offense (359.0 YPG) and #5 in scoring (28.9 PPG), and QB Sam Darnold comes in off a 330-yard, 4-TD performance in their 38-14 win over WAS. SEA also holds major defensive efficiency edges, allowing only 18.8 PPG and ranking #11 in total defense, while ARI's defense sits around league average. Trends lean toward SEA as well - they've won 8 straight in the series (7-1 ATS), though ARI has covered 5 straight on the road. The matchup likely hinges on whether ARI can keep pressure off Brissett, as SEA's defense should be able to dictate pace at home in a controlled game environment. **Detroit by 14 over WASHINGTON** - DET brings one of the league's most efficient offenses into this matchup, ranking #11 in total offense (350.8 YPG) and #2 in scoring (29.9 PPG). QB Jared Goff threw for 284 yards and 2 TDs last week while TE Sam LaPorta and WR Amon-Ra St. Brown both posted 97 receiving yards, continuing the rhythm of a passing attack that has produced consistency even in tight losses. WAS now turns to backup QB Mariota with Jayden Daniels out for the season, and the offense already struggled last week with just 199 total yards in the loss to SEA, while WR Terry McLaurin also remains sidelined. Defensively, WAS has allowed 26.2 PPG and ranks #28 in total defense, while DET is 7-1 ATS after allowing fewer than 150 pass yards the previous week. The matchup leans heavily toward DET's stability on both sides of the ball we think they bounce back strong after the letdown last week.

Pittsburgh at LA CHARGERS - SNF - PIT comes in off a game where their defense forced 6 turnovers, including 3 INTs of Daniel Jones, but they were also outgained 391-234 and continue to struggle generating explosive offense (just 288.1 YPG, #28). RB Jaylen Warren scored twice late, but PIT averaged only 1.9 YPC on the ground and allowed 5 sacks, a concern against a LAC front that recorded 6 sacks last week vs TEN and ranks #6 in total defense (286.8 YPG). QB Justin Herbert threw for 250 yards and 2 TD last week while also adding a rushing score, and LAC continues to lean on a top-5 offense (374.6 YPG, #5) even if the scoring output has been inconsistent. PIT has been excellent situationally (9-2 ATS after allowing >250 pass yards) but LAC has played higher-variance games at home, with the Over hitting in 8 of their last 10 in this building. This sets up as a stylistic contrast: PIT's grind-and-defend approach vs LAC's efficiency and pressure. ***Get the Sunday Night NFL Marquee online at ncsports.com or call the office at 1-800-654-3448 after 11:00am ET.**

Philadelphia at GREEN BAY - PHI should get WR A.J. Brown back this week after sitting out, which is key for a passing offense that managed just 304.4 YPG (#24) so far but still sits #10 in scoring at 26.0 PPG thanks to red-zone efficiency. GB comes in off a frustrating home loss despite outgaining CAR 361-179, with QB Jordan Love throwing for 273 yards and RB Josh Jacobs adding 87 on the ground, but they stalled repeatedly in scoring range. GB's defense has been the more stable unit (#5 in YPG allowed, #8 in scoring defense), while PHI has been vulnerable to explosive pass plays (336.2 YPG allowed, #23). The Eagles have thrived in step-up games (5-0 ATS vs winning teams) and their offense tends to push totals higher (Over 6-0 in that same sample), while GB has been strong in Lambeau, especially in B2B home situations (4-0 SU, 3-1 ATS). This sets up as strength-on-strength: PHI's playmakers returning versus a GB defense that rarely breaks, with both offenses capable of moving the ball steadily.
