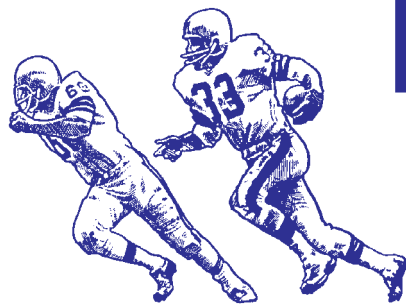

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ NEW MEXICO over Colorado St - New Mexico is heavily favored to end a 13 game losing streak to CSU (2-11 ATS). Lobos have surprised in HC Eck's debut. They're 6-3 straight wins, and will bowl for first time since '16. They're also off a bye are off their two best performances, beating UNLV by 5 on the road and Utah St by 19 at home. Offense coming off ssn-high 532 yds by using unique QB mix of Jack Layne's arm with James Laubstein's legs. Meanwhile, CSU fading at 2-7 with 3 straight DD losses. Rams led by interim staff that doesn't know where it'll be coaching next yr and D yielded 532 rush yds (7.1) past 2 gms. UNM playing with confidence and motivation entering the final stretch. Lobos will take out more than a decade's worth of frustration on the Rams, rushing for over 200 yds in a blowout win and an easy cover laying just over 2 td's.

FORECAST: NEW MEXICO by 28

3★ USf over NAVY - The winner of this game remains in control of their own destiny to reach the American Title game. USF just blasted UTSA at home LW. They led 42-10 at half and won 55-23. The Bulls haven't seen the option yet this year. LY against Navy they were outgained 255-105 in the 1H and trailed 28-0. The Bulls did beat Navy LTH in '23 44-30 and had a 435-330 yd edge. Navy was w/o QB Horvath LW against Notre Dame. They were outgained 502-228 and lost 49-10 (+27). The Middies have lost 2 straight but both were on the road. They are 5-0 SU but they've been DD chalk in all 5 home games and are 1-4 ATS. USF QB Byrum Brown has a 19-6 ratio and is their #1 rusher (705, 5.5). Navy is #127 in our Pass D Rankings (66%, 15-4). The Bulls have won at Florida and North Texas and led Memphis by 2 scores 4Q. USF has ply'd a much tougher sked (#65 vs #106) and they win by 3 td's.

FORECAST: USf by 21

3★ DUKE over Virginia - This game gives us fond memories of our first two Sept 5★'s in '84 & '85. Both teams are coming off a SU loss. Duke was caught in an ACC sandwich LW when they played UConnand lost 37-34 (-8). The Blue Devils are 5-4 but only have 1 ACC loss. They are +46 ypg and +35 vs the ACC. UVA's 7 game win streak ended LW. They had a 327-203 yd edge vs Wake Forest but QB Morris was dinged up (CS) and down 16-9 they were SOD at the WF5 late 4Q. The Cavaliers are +98 ypg and +53 vs the ACC but they lost at NCST, were outgained 383-237 but won by a fg at L'ville, UNC missed a 2 pt conv and UVA won in OT and they only led 24-21 at Cal then got a pick-6. QB Mensah has a 24-4 ratio. Duke has ply'd the tougher sked (#42 vs #67). Duke is 18-5 SU at home since '22 and the home team is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series. Morris is a big ? for UVA and we like Duke by DD's at home.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Arkansas (+) over LSU - Arkansas is 12-5-1 ATS vs LSU since '07 despite losing 8 of the last 9 SU. Prior to last year's 4 straight meetings were decided by 3 points. Both tms have Interim HC's looking for their first win. LW was LSU's first game under Frank Wilson and they lost to Bama 20-9 (+10'). Ark has lost all 4 games since Petrino took over, but they've had 5 losses by 6 points or less including at Ole Miss, at Tenn and at home vs A&M. LSU has the much stronger D allowing just 19 ppg/328 ypg, but Ark has the more potent offense, putting up 35 ppg/484 ypg. Ark is getting 6 points on the road and they've proven they can stay within that number against better teams than LSU so we are calling for the upset.

FORECAST: Arkansas by 3

2★ GEORGIA SOUTHERN over Coastal Carolina - After losing 3 straight, GS has won b2b mtgs SU & ATS. Coastal wants revenge for last yr's 26-6 loss as 2pt fav. After starting 2-3, Chants have been one of SBC's surprise tms. They've won 4 straight (5-1 ATS last 6) and can still win East. Offense has gotten spark from Samari Collier and rush gm that's averaged 268 yds & 5.8 ypc during streak. Chants now face a GS run D allowing 223 ypg & 5.6 ypc. The 4-5 Eagles got off the mat last wk to upset App St, 25-23. Plus, they're 4-0 ATS, +13ppg and +59ypg at home, and coming off their best gm at stopping the run (77 yds, 3.3 ypc). Coastal is streaking but GS is a different tm at home. After b2b road gms and upset of App St, Eagles derail Chants SBC title hopes.

OTHER GAMES

Wednesday November 12th

Northern Illinois by 14 over UMass - Huskies are 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS vs Minutemen. This is NIU's last ssn in MAC (moving to MWC), while it is UMass' first ssn since rejoining MAC TY. Both are 2-7 ATS but while NIU is 2-7 SU, UMass is the only FBS team without a SU win (0-9). Both are 1-4 ATS in MAC play. UMass' covered vs Buffalo (+15, losing 21-28) while NIU cover was vs Ball St (-6, 21-7 win). Surprisingly no common foes. These teams have the two worst scoring offenses (UMass 11.3 ppg, NIU 12 ppg). However NIU has a big defensive edge (#93-136) as UMass is allowing 37 ppg & 331 ypg including 188 ypg rush (4.6 ypc) which is playing to NIU offensive strength with 159 ypg rush (4.2 ypc). Look for NIU to have their best game of the season.

Toledo by 1 over MIAMI, OH - Have met 3x L/2 years with Rockets winning & Covering both regular season games but Miami pulling off the upset in the '23 MAC Chmp game. LT UT (-6') led 20-6 HT & 30-13 4Q holding on for a 30-20 win (396-350 yd edge). Both are 5-4 SU & 3-3 ATS but Toledo has 2 MAC losses vs MU's 1. Against 3 common foes (NIU, WM, UA) Miami is 3-0 SU & ATS (+11 ppg, +105 ypg) while UT is 2-1 SU & ATS (+26 ppg, +209 ypg, beat Akron 45-3 400 yds). Rockets have Off (#63-97) & Def (#48-66) edges but MU has ST edge (#14-47). LW Miami (-2') suffered their first MAC loss of ssn 24-20 at Ohio, while UT (-14') blew out NIU 42-3 too keep them undefeated TY at home. The home & away switch here. UT is 0-4 SU on the road incl 0-3 ATS L/3 while Miami is 1-3 SU & ATS at home but 3-0 SU & ATS L/3. Play on the home dog

Buffalo by 1 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - Bulls are 3-1 SU & ATS vs Chippewas since '18 but HT has won & covered 3 straight. Both come in 5-4 SU with CM 6-3 ATS & UB 4-5 ATS. UB is also tied for top of MAC at 4-1 SU (1-4 ATS) while CM is 3-2 SU but 4-1 ATS in MAC play. This is just CM's fourth HG & they are 3-0 SU & ATS at home. Against 4 common foe both are 3-1 SU but CM is 3-1 ATS while UB is 1-3 ATS. Last met in '23 when UB was also the dog (+3). UB led 23-7 HT & 37-13 4Q before a CM td w/2:43 left for a 37-19 outright upset. Bulls are only MAC team with a winning road record at 3-1 SU (2-2 ATS). Buffalo is also 3-0 ATS as a dog TY. With so many factors for both, this should be a close game, so we will take the points & the Bulls.

Thursday November 13th

OLD DOMINION by 13 over Troy - Both tms 4-1 ATS last 5 off bye. ODU bowl-eligible at 6-3 SU & 5-4 ATS. Monarchs 4-0 at home but 2-2 ATS. After b2b blowout losses to Marshall & JMU, they rebounded with wins over App St & ULM. ODU led by offense gaining 93ypg above foes avg (#16 FBS). QB Colton Joseph has 19-9 ratio and leads with 620 (5.8) rushing. D hit rock bottom vs JMU but only allows 4.1 ypc & 253 ypg at home (+27 ppg & +275 ypg at home). Troy looking to rebound after 23-10 loss to Ark St that snapped 5-gm win streak. Trojans can still win the West. They were outgained 3 times during win streak, and offense gains 76 ypg less than opp avg (#127 FBS). Their strength is on D, allowing 24ppg and 4.2 ypc while bagging 24 sacks. Joseph gets a Thurs night audience to showcase his talents. He'll use it to lead ODU to 13-point win.

Friday November 14th

CLEMSON by 3 over LOUISVILLE - Clemson has won all 4 previous trips to Louisville (3-1 ATS). Tigers are out for revenge for LY's 33-21 (-10') loss. They had a 31-19 FD edge in the game. Clemson's Bowl hopes are back on track after beating Florida St 24-10 (-1') LW. The Tigers got back QB Klubnik who threw for 221 and Clemson led 18-0 2Q. UL was -18' yet lost to Cal 29-26, which was one of our 3 Big Dog Outright Winners (23 outright upsets TY, +3295 ML, just \$15 on NCSports.com!) The Cardinals allowed a season high 427 yards including 350 passing. QB Moss only has an 11-6 ratio and RB Brown is out. Klubnik should be better in his 2nd start back from injury. UL is 0-6 ATS at home this year while Clemson won their L/2 road games by combined 79-20. Clemson has ply'd the tougher sked (#27 vs #60). We have Clemson winning outright and they are the underdog.

OREGON by 31 over Minnesota - 1st trip to Eugene & first reg season game with Oregon since '75 (split Sun Bowl meetings in '99 & '03). Minn 4-1-2 ATS last 6 Western trips. Under HC Fleck, Minn 12-5-1 to the over after bye & 12-6 ATS. Oregon has never hosted Minn. Last 20 vs B10, Oregon 21-5 SU & 14-11-1 ATS. Ducks 13-9 ATS as DD conf fav under HC Lanning. In its last game Minn led Mich St 10-0 at half, but needed OT to win 23-20. Oregon opened 7-1 but lost to Indiana at home. LW Oregon used a FG w/ :03 left to defeat Iowa on the road, 18-16 (-4'). Minnesota's offense has just 259 ypg the last 4 games and Oregon is holding foes to 137 ypg below their average. Gophers are 0-3 on the road, losing by 30 ppg. We see that trend continuing this week - Oregon wins big.

Saturday November 15th

UCONN by 5 over Air Force - UConn 6-13 vs academies but 6-1 ATS last 7 gms Senior Days. Huskies playing well for Jim Mora. After going 9-4 LY, they're 7-3 with wins over BC & Duke. They shocked Duke, 37-34, last wk with late td from QB Joe Fagnano (69%, 25-0 ratio!). UConn 5-0 SU & 4-1 ATS at home and +23ppg and +135ypg. D leads FBS with 35 sacks. Huskies saw option vs Rice and allowed 300 rush yds in 37-34 loss. AF improving but still 3-6. Falcons still beat SJ St, 26-16, despite -133 yds. Last 3 losses were by only 3 pts. Offense has stalled (under 400yds 3 str gms) as D stabilized (19ppg last 3). Falcons won with TOs last wk, but UConn leads FBS with fewest TO's. Plus, Fagnano faces 135th ranked pass D. Huskies stay hot at home with 5 pt win but AF stays within 7 point line.

Utsa by 21 over CHARLOTTE - These two last met as CUSA members and UTSA won both meetings in '15 & '16. It's hard to imagine they would lose another road game to Charlotte who is 0-8 SU/2-5-1 ATS vs FBS foes and -169 ypg vs conf foes. LW they trailed 28-0 2Q at ECar but it was only 38-22 3Q. CLT was only outgd 407-324 and lost by 26 (+28'). UTSA is 4-5 SU/ATS and -19 ypg vs conf foes. This is a must win to reach a bowl with tough games against ECar and Army on deck. Charlotte is 4-17 ATS as a home dog since '21 but UTSA is 1-10 SU/2-9 ATS on the road the last 2 years. Hard to trust either team in their role but we do have UTSA by 3 td's.

GEORGIA by 10 over Texas - Georgia won both meetings LY. They dominated the regular season mtg on the road 30-15 (+5) then rallied to win in the SEC Title game 22-19 (+3). Georgia played their best game LW when they won at Miss St 41-21 (-9) and finished w/a 567-322 yd edge. QB Stockton threw 3 td passes and now has a 15-2 ratio. RB Frazier was 12-181. UGA has been notoriously slow starters and they let Miss St score first then scored the next 38 points. Texas is fresh off a bye. They trailed Miss St by 17 4Q in their last road game but won in OT then led Vandy by 24 4Q and only won by 3 which resulted in a ridiculous push. Manning has thrown for over 300 in their L/2. UGA had a 33 game home win streak broken vs Bama earlier TY and they are 6-1 as a HF vs Top 10 teams s/20. Texas is 0-4 ATS in true road games including losses at OSUand Florida. Bulldogs are laying just under a td. They already beat Texas away from home twice LY so we like them at home.

JAMES MADISON by 28 over Appalachian St - JMU has lost last 2 in series. Dukes 8-1 and not just the SBC fav but also contender for G5 playoff berth. They're +27ppg & +281ypg at home, and their only loss is to Louisville. Dukes offense heating up while D holds opp 129ypg below their avg (#2 FBS). They allow 3.0 ypc & 52% through air which is a big challenge for App St offense that's #102 in rushing. AppSt has lost 3 straight to fall to 4-5. Last Thurs they spotted Ga Southern 19-0 lead and gave up 494 yds in 25-23 loss. Run D solid (3.5 ypc) but pass D has allowed 300+ yds in 5 of last 6gms so JMU's Alonza Barnett (16-4) will go up top Saturday. App St lacks the balance to the JMU D and the stoppers to contain Barnett. Dukes remain on their title track with blowout win.

CINCINNATI by 11 over Arizona - Cincy had bye to get over Utah loss and prepare for Arizona. Bearcats still in Big 12 mix. They host BYU next wk so possible lookahead spot. Cincy 5-0 and +25ppg & +116ypg at home, while Cats rarely play in EST or cold weather. However, Arizona has #1 pass eff D (-7/12 ratio), and Bearcat QB Brendan Sorsby's 2 worst gms are against 2 best defenses (Nebraska/Utah). Cats 6-3 with Saturday's comeback over Kansas. While Arizona holds opp 63ypg below their avg (#29 FBS), Cincy gives up 31ypg more than foes avg (#103). In QB battle, Sorsby (2-1 ratio) has the rest and home cooking edge on Noah Fifita (23-4). After 6 straight wks of action, Cincy is recharged. They'll get back on track with 11 pt win.

EAST CAROLINA by 3 over Memphis - These two last met in '22. EC is 9-2 SU/8-3 ATS in the series but Memphis covered 3 of the L/4. Memphis squandered their chance to win the American and reach their playoffs by losing to Tulane LW. QB Lewis returned from injury and threw for 317 yards. They trailed 38-17 4Q but were only down 6 and were SOD on their final possession. EC is 6-3 SU/5-4 ATS. They were -28' LW and led CLT 28-0 2Q but it was only 38-22 4Q and they won by 26. The Pirates are +131 in AAC play while Memphis is +33. Memphis has a big ST's edge (#60 vs #111). Memphis has actually been better on the road this year, going 4-1 ATS and +91 ypg. Memphis keeps it within a fg.

Marshall by 10 over GEORGIA ST - Home tm 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS in series. B2B losses pushed Marshall to 4-5 and brink of missing bowl. However, Herd 6-3 ATS and losses were to Coastal & JMU, and they outgained both. They've gone over 400 yds 6 straight gms led by QB Carlos Del Rio-Wilson (14-3 ratio, 490 rushing). However, pass D ranks #91 with a 19-9 ratio. GS 1-8 SU & ATS with 6 str losses. Offense has perked up around QB Cameran Brown (13-1 ratio), and tm just -8ppg and +8ypg at home. But D has given up at least 38pts last 4gms and allows 68ypg above opp avg (#124 FBS). GS pass D 126th with 18-2 ratio, creating a bad matchup with Del Rio-Wilson. QBs will duke it out in shootout. With better balance, Herd breaks losing streak with DD win.

Georgia Tech by 21 over BOSTON COLLEGE - BC has won the last 3 meetings and are 4-0 ATS vs GT. They last met in '23 when GT was -5' at home but were upset 38-23. GT is fresh off a bye and they have a key ACC game vs Pitt on deck but must win this game first. The Jackets are only +22 ypg vs the ACC. This is BC's Senior Day. They've lost all 9 games vs FBS foes this year. They are -189 ypg in their L/6 and -151 vs the ACC. The Eagles had covered 2 straight going into LW but were no match for SMU in a 45-13 (+10') home loss. This is a clear look ahead spot for GT who doesn't do well as a favorite. They've only been a DD AF once under Key and they were nearly upset at WF. BC is playing an 8th straight week while GT is angry off a loss and off a bye so they come in more focused.

FLORIDA ST by 21 over Virginia Tech - Battle of teams just fighting to make a bowl. VT is fresh off a bye and 2 weeks ago they led L'ville 16-7 at half but were outscored 21-0 in 2H and finished w/just 240 yards. The Hokies are 3-6 SU/2-7 ATS but only -14 ypg vs the ACC. FSU is 4-5 SU/ATS and are coming off a 24-10 (+1') loss to Clemson. They were held to a ssn low 360 yards. FSU has the coaching edge with their staff still in tact and they've ply'd the tougher sked (#39 vs #57). Hard to be confident in either side but FSU is at home and they have a big edge on offense (#5 vs #91) and call for a 21 point edge.

INDIANA by 35 over Wisconsin - Badgers own series edge 41-20-2 but have been upset the last 2. Last time here Wisconsin (-9) fell, 20-14, despite outgaining Hoosiers, 344-261. First 3 years under HC Fickell, Badgers 7-11 SU & 8-10 ATS on road. Indiana has won last 2 ('20 & '23 as dogs) after dropping previous 10 to Wisc. In '23, Hoosiers held Badgers to 101 rush yds & never trailed. Indiana is a dominant team and opened 9-0 SU & 6-3 ATS. LW Indiana rallied to beat Penn St, 27-24 (-13'). Wisconsin opened just 2-6 SU and have taken on the nations toughest schedule. LW Wisconsin upset #23 Washington at home, 13-10 (+10') but they haven't reached 300 yards since their 2nd game. HC Cignetti is 11-3 ATS as a HF with Indy & 17-8 overall. We see the Hoosiers going over big and remaining red-hot.

MIAMI, FL by 21 over NC State - UM won 4 meetings from '12-'21 but NCSU pulled the upset in '23, 20-6. UM still has playoff hopes at 7-2 SU/5-4 ATS. The 'Canes led Syracuse 38-3 but gave up a td w/ :21 left. NCSU opened 3-0 but they've lost 4 of their L/6. They were a home dog (+5) vs GTech who was feeling unbeaten pressure and doesn't play well as a favorite. NCSU's D is allowing 460 ypg in ACC play and they've allowed over 340 pass yds in 3 straight. RB Hollywood Smothers leads the ACC with (825, 6.9) was out for their game vs GTech. The 'Canes need style points to impress the committee and Cristobal is known to tack on late td's so we say lay the points.

Penn St by 13 over MICHIGAN ST - PSU has won last 2 (35-16 in '22/42-0 in '23). In '23, Lions outgained Sparty 586-53 and pitched 1st shutout vs MSU in series history. MSU has dropped last 2 to PSU & 4 of last 5 (1-2-2 ATS). Last 10 after bye week, Spartans 4-7 SU & 5-5-1 ATS. Michigan St won their first 3 SU but were 0-3 ATS. They lost the next 6 but had 3 back door covers in the 6 weeks. They did have a 467-301-yd edge at Minny as they switched to Milivojevic at QB. Penn St was preseason #2 but lost to Oregon in OT, then were upset by UCLA & N'western & Franklin was fired. They also lost QB Allar for the year. They lost by 1 at Iowa &, despite trailing Ohio St 21-14 at half, lost 38-14. LW Penn St hung with Indiana, but lost 27-24 in the waning moments (+13'). Mich St is fresh off a bye while Penn St just faced OSU & Indy with Nebraska on deck. As a road favorite over last 4 seasons, Lions are 10-3 ATS! We like PSU to bounce back.

OHIO ST by 38 over UCLA - Last of 4 Midwest trips for UCLA in '25. Bruins 1st OSU trip since '99 (lost 42-30 +11). As a RD vs ranked teams, UCLA 7-6 ATS last 13 (covered last year vs LSU/PSU). Bruins 3-0 ATS as DD dog in '24 (1-1 TY). Series tied 4-4-1. Last meeting in '01 (OSU 13-6 loss in Pasadena). UCLA opened 0-3 with a 35-10 loss to New Mexico and HC Foster was fired. The new staff excelled as they only lost at Northwestern 17-14, then with Neuheisel taking over as OC won 3 straight. They did lose to Indiana 56-6 on the road. LW UCLA fell to Nebraska, 28-21 (-1'). QB lamaleava returns to Horseshoe after losing playoff game there w/ UT LY. Ohio St opened 9-0 SU & 7-2 ATS, winning by an average of 40-7 at home and +267 ypg. LW OSU defeated Purdue 34-10 (-30'). Since 2019, Buckeyes are 28-17 ATS as a home favorite.

Notre Dame by 17 over PITTSBURGH - ND has won the last 4 (3-1 ATS). They last met in '23 when ND blasted Pitt 58-7 w/a 535-255 yd edge. Pitt is 7-2 SU/ATS and they led by DD's in their losses to WV and L'ville. ND is on a 7 game win streak and this is a must-win for their playoff hopes. LW Navy was missing QB Horvath and ND won 49-10 (-27) w/a 502-228 yd edge. HC Narduzzi didn't hide the fact that this game isn't as important to Pitt with GT and Miami on deck and a chance to make the ACC Title game. Narduzzi said "it is not an ACC game...They could put up 100 on us as long as we win the next two after that". We like the Irish D against Pitt's frosh QB. ND is 18-5 ATS vs the ACC and they clearly have the motivation edge.

BALL ST by 3 over Eastern Michigan - LY (new MAC format) was first time these teams had not met s/1973. EM is 5-3 SU & 6-2 ATS in series s/ '16 winning & covering L/2. In '23 EM (-2') led 17-10 HT & won 24-10 despite being outgained 305-253. Vs 2 common foes (NIU & Ohio). Ball St (+14) beat Ohio 20-14 but lost to NIU 20-7 (+6). EM (+2) beat NIU 16-10 but lost to Ohio 28-21 (+11'). EM is 3-7 SU (all 3 wins at home) & 5-5 ATS including 1-4 ATS on the road (only cover vs UB). Ball St at 4-5 SU still has a shot at a bowl bid & are 6-3 ATS. EM has edges on Off (#96-135) & ST (#95-#131). LW at home EM (-2) beat BG 27-21. LW at home Ball St (-3) beat Kent St 17-3. The most important facts are EM is just 6-6 as a road favorite in HC Creighton's 12 ssn's & are 0-5 SU & 1-4 ATS on the road this year (only cover vs UB). Ball St on the other hand is 4-0 SU & ATS at home including twice as a HD. Surprisingly Ball St is a home dog here so go with Cardinals.

ALABAMA by 3 over Oklahoma - Bama is out for revenge after they had their playoff hopes crushed by OK LY. Bama put up just 3 points and 234 yards in a 21 pt loss. The Tide have won 8 straight but their covers have been by a thin margin. LW they were -10' vs LSU and they won 20-9. If OK pulls the upset then the playoffs are on the table. The Sooners are fresh off a bye and won at Tenn two wks ago. Bama's run game has been their weakness, avg 112 (3.5) and OK allows just 82 (2.5) rush ypg as they've held their L/7 foes under 4 ypc. QB Ty Simpson has a 21-1 ratio but OK has allowed just 7 pass td's all year. This is a much better Sooners team than the banged up version that Bama lost to LY and their defense will keep this game very close.

Delaware by 11 over SAM HOUSTON - First mtg for former FCS programs in transition. SH is off an absurd misleading final where they were -317 yards and -20 FD's but beat Oregon St 21-17 for Phil Longo's first win. The Bearkats are -176 ypg and -106 vs CUSA. Delaware continues to surprise after upsetting LA Tech 25-24 (+6). The Blue Hens have lost 3 of their road games but those were at Colo, Jax St and Liberty. Delaware QB Minicucci (17-6 ratio) will expose a SH D that allows 73% and 268 pass ypg. Blue Hens get their 6th win

TULSA by 3 over Oregon St - First mtg. Both tms are staying home for bowl ssn. Tulsa has lost 5 straight, -21 ppg/96 ypg in those. Oregon St had a 474-157 yd edge yet managed to hand Sam Houston their first win of the ssn. The Beavers are actually +86 ypg in their L/4 and they've

had close four close losses. On paper Oregon St is the better team but they have an interim HC and players who will likely be looking for a new home soon while Tulsa's staff will remain in tact and we give the home team a 3 pt edge.

SOUTHERN MISS by 7 over Texas St - USM has lost b2b to Texas St incl 58-3 last yr. At 7-2 with 5-gm win streak, USM is in West driver's seat. Eagles 4-1 SU & ATS at home with only SU loss to Miss St. However, they've been outgained 3 of 4 home gms vs FBS. Offense led by QB Braylon Braxton (19-5 ratio) while D creates havoc (#2 in FBS takeaways). Bobcats were supposed to contend but are 3-6 with 5-gm losing streak. Four of the losses were by 1 score, and they outgained 4 opp incl Louisiana in last wk's 42-39 loss (528-384). Offense is dynamite, cranking out 117ypg above opp avg (#11 FBS) but D has allowed 433pg during losing streak. USM is the far more complete tm here and stays on track. But backdoor is always vulnerable with Texas St.

TEXAS TECH by 31 over Ucf - With last week's 29-7 domination of unbeaten BYU, TT left no doubt about Big 12 frontrunner. Red Raiders had 1 stumble vs ASU but all 9 of their wins were by at least 3 td's. In Lubbock, they're winning by avg of 48-10 and outgaining opp by 254ypg. TT is potent on offense but exceptional on D, holding opp 106ypg below their avg (#10 FBS). They lead FBS in run D (2.4 ypc). Knights 0-3 on road, where they avg 11ppg. In their last road gm at Baylor, they had 225yds & 3 pts and TT has much better D. UCF won't be able to run the ball which pressures a pass gm with 6-8 ratio. Red Raiders defensive dominance will eliminate any chance for post-BYU win hangover. TT will roll comfortably by more than 4 td's.

Kansas St by 25 OKLAHOMA ST - Home tm on 7-0 ATS run, and KSU 1-8 SU last 9 trips to Stillwater. Wildcats have gone from Big 12 contender to needing 2 wins to bowl. They've been up-and-down all yr, losing 3 times as fav. D has been solid, but the offense has gone over 400 yds just once vs FBS tm. OSU has been worse. Cowboys have lost 8 straight and are 3-6 ATS. In Big 12 gms, they're -26ppg and -168ypg. Only 3 schools have thrown fewer td passes (6) and interim staff already has one foot in '26. KSU has the superior D, and QB Avery Johnson is a playmaker with 16-4 ratio and 343 rush yds. While focus and motivation could be issues on the road, they can simply out talent an Oklahoma St squad that's been overmatched all year in Big 12 play.

Utah by 15 BAYLOR - Both tms off byes. At 7-2 & 4-2 in Big 12 play, Utes still in conf mix but need help after losses to TT & BYU. Since BYU loss, they've hammered Colorado & Cinc by 98-21 combined. Utah +26 ppg & +178 ypg, and D holds opp 89 ypg below their avg (#16 FBS). Most important for this wk, they're #2 in pass D (50%, 6-8 ratio). Baylor begins final leg at 5-4 SU & 2-7 ATS. The Sawyer Robertson-led offense has been good enough to win just about every gm. Robertson is hitting 63% with a 26-7 ratio. But the D allows 22 ypg more than foes average (#90 FBS). And in 3 gms with mobile QB's, Bears allowed 45 to SMU, 34 to K-State and 41 to Cincy. This is a good spot for a healthy Devon Dampier to exploit a poor Baylor D with a Big12-worst 9 sacks.

OLE MISS by 11 over Florida - This series has been highlighted by some big upsets including LY when Ole Miss was -13 at Florida and lost 24-17 which cost the Rebels a playoff spot. In fact, the dog is 6-1 SU/ATS since 2002. Ole Miss is only off a 49-0 win over The Citadel. Five of their six wins over P4 teams have been by single-digits. QB Lagway was benched in the 2H of FL's embarrassing 38-7 loss at KY LW but interim HC Gonzales says he will start against Ole Miss. FL only lost by 4 to Georgia and beat Texas. They have ply'd the #1 toughest sked (Ole Miss #49 sked). Gators are getting over 2 td's and coming off an embarrassing performance we expect better.

MISSOURI by 6 over Mississippi St - Mizzou won at MSU 39-20 (-8') LY. The Tigers are off B2B losses and true frosh QB Matt Zollers was dreadful in his first start, hitting just 7-22 for 77 yards but that was against A&M and he faces an MSU D that has allowed 471 ypg in their L/6. MSU still needs a win to reach a bowl for the first time under Jeff Lebby. The Bulldogs have close losses to Teas, Florida and Tenn. LW MSU led UGA 7-0 then gave up 38 straight points and lost 41-21 (+9), outgained 567-322. QB Blake Shapen has left the L/2 gms with an injury. Backup QB Kamario Taylor has a 3-0 ratio and adds a dual threat ability with 200 rush (5.9). MSU has ply'd the tougher sked (#18 vs #46) but the Tigers are outgained both Bama and Vandy and are +17 vs SEC while MSU is -110. Drinkwitz has 0 losses in the L3Y to SEC teams that finish with a losing conf record but MSU has kept it close against some of the SEC's better teams.

TULANE by 14 over Fau - FAU travels to Tulane for the first time. Last met in '23 when Tulane was - and won 24-8. Jake Retzlaff had his best game as a Tulane QB LW when they beat Memphis 38-32 (+3), throwing for 332 and 3 td's. FAU is 4-5 SU/5-4 ATS and still have an outside shot at a bowl. QB Caden Veltkamp has a 12-4 ratio in his L/5 games and Tulane's D is allowing 67% and they gave up 300+ pass yards in four gms this year. FAU has ply'd a much tougher sked (#44 vs #103). That was a huge win for Tulane LW and now they are laying 17'. Even if FAU gets behind they have backdoor potential so we like the dog to cover.

TEXAS A&M by 24 over South Carolina - A&M is out for revenge for LY's 44-20 (-3) loss to South Carolina where they were outgained 530-350. SC has covered the L/3 in the series. Aggies are 9-0 SU and they've covered 5 of their L/7. The Gamecocks are 3-6 SU/4-5 ATS and they've lost their 3 SEC road games by an avg of 11.7 ppg and they are -151 ypg in true road gms. QB Sellers only has a 7-5 ratio. SC's Oline has allowed 34 scaks including 28 in 7 SEC games and they face A&M's Cashius Howell who has 10.5 sacks this year. A&M's offense is putting up 38 ppg/460 ypg and 110 ypg more than foes allow on avg while SC avg 20 ppg/294 ypg and putting up 24 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. With Samford on deck, A&M is full tilt and wins by over 3 td's.

South Alabama by 9 ULM - Both tms off last wk. With 31-22 loss to Louisiana before break, 2-7 Jaguars guaranteed to finish under .500 for first time since '21. They're 1-4 in gms decided by SD's and -5 ppg and -11 ypg, so they're closer to .500 than record shows. After starting 3-1, ULM has lost last 5 gms by an avg score of 36-11. Pass gm (55%, 12-10 ratio) unable to stretch defenses, while D is giving up 55ypg more than the opp avg (#120 FBS). For all its problems in tight gms, USA has the better playmakers here. QB Bishop Davenport (66%, 12-5) has been solid as Gio Lopez's replacement, Kentrel Bullock has rushed for 729 (4.6), and WR Devin Voinis leads the team with 654 (13.1). Jags' superior offense will be the difference in a road win in Monroe.

North Carolina by 3 over WAKE FOREST

North Carolina (+) over Wake Forest - North Carolina has won the last 4 meetings. The home team is 10-3 SU/9-4 ATS but the visitor has covered 3 of the L/4. The Tar Heels have won 2 straight and their last 2 losses were by just 4 combined points. They fumbled at the goal line in a 3 pt loss to Cal then were +94 yds vs UVA but fumbled at the goal line 1Q and missed a 2 pt conv in OT for a 1 pt loss. We took a crushing backdoor loss LW when NC led Stanford 20-3 (-7) then gave up 75 & 80 yd td drives in the final 9 minutes to only win by 5. WF had just 203 yds LW at Virginia but were +3 TO's and won 16-9 (+6). NC has allowed just 16 ppg/255 ypg in their L/4 and they've held those foes 117 ypg below their avg. WF allows 20 ppg/325 ypg and holds foes 92 ypg below their avg. We expect a low scoring game and with both teams coming off misleading finals our lean is with the underdog Tar Heels.

North Texas by 14 over UAB - NT has a great shot to reach the AAC Title game with just 1 conf loss and they only have UAB/Rice/Temple remaining. UAB dominated this series when they were in CUSA (5-1 SU/6-0 ATS but NT won the last meeting 45-42 (-2) in '23 as AAC members. NT had close wins on the road against WMich and Army. Their D is allowing 24 ppg and 364 ypg but 24 ypg more than their foes avg. UAB has ply'd their backup QB, Ryder Burton for most of the L/3 gms and he has a 7-3 ratio. They are 3-1 SU/1-3 ATS in home games and that includes an upset win over Memphis. Blazers D has ben better lately, allowing 365 in their L/4. UAB is 3-0 ATS as a dog of over 2 td's and they have the offense to keep this closer than expected.

ILLINOIS by 21 over Maryland - Terps have made only one trip to Champaign and that was in '21. Maryland (-7) scored 10 pts in final 2:13 for 20-17 win. Just 3 all-time meetings. Illinois trails 1-2, but won last meeting in '23, 27-24, on road as 13-pt dog. Illinois was a prime contender for a playoff spot & opened 5-1 but the loss was 63-10 to Indiana. They did upset USC at home. Maryland, as usual, opened strong in non-conf. play at 3-0 then knocked off Wisconsin 27-10 on the road. They led Washington 20-3 in the 4Q, led Nebraska 31-24 in 4Q, lost by 3 to UCLA on FG with :02 left then were blasted by Indiana 55-10. LW Maryland fell to Rutgers on road, 35-20 (+1). Under HC Bielema, Ill 6-2 SU & ATS after bye. Bielema is 9-12-1 ATS as a HF with the Illini (3-1 TY). Since '16, Terps are 7-22-1 ATS as an AD in B10 games (1-0-1 TY).

Michigan by 14 over NORTHWESTERN - Scheduled for Wrigley Field. Since '00, Michigan leads 13-2 (road loss '00; home loss '08). UM on a current 8-game win streak & 7 on road. UM has covered 3 of last 4 (ATS loss '18 in Evanston). NW has dropped last 8 to Mich (3-5 ATS) & hasn't won at home since '00. Home team has covered 5 straight in series, with Michigan wins at NW by just 20-17, 10-9 & 27-19. Cats lost in Ann Arbor LY, 50-6, for worst series loss since '91. Michigan is still alive for a possible playoff berth with their 2 losses both on the road vs Oklahoma & USC. The Wolverines are 7-2 SU and 3-6 ATS. The D is holding foes to 86 ypg below their average. Northwestern opened 5-2 SU & ATS. LW Northwestern lost at USC 38-17 (+13). NW avg 10 pts over last 6 meetings. Michigan is fresh off a bye & only has Maryland on deck & should have the crowd edge as their fans travel well to Chicago. We like Michigan by 2 TDs.

Kennesaw St by 1 over JACKSONVILLE ST - These two are both 5-0 SU in CUSA play and the winner has a great shot to reach the conf title game. KSU has won 7 straight and are +14 ppg vs CUSA but only +17 ypg. The Owls led NMST 24-7 LW but only won 24-21 (-9). Jax St has won 4 straight and all 3 of their losses are on the road (UCF/GA Sthm & SMiss). The Gamecocks are +6 ppg and +25 ypg vs CUSA. RB Cook leads CUSA with 1,181 (5.9) and they have dual threat QB Caden Creel (706 pass, 603 rush). KSU has a solid run D but JSU just ran for 275 against UTEP who led CUSA in tfl's. Hard to pick a side but KSU is -3' and JSU is tough at home so we lean with the dog.

BYU by 13 over Tcu - BYU looking to rebound from tough first loss at Texas Tech. Still, all of their goals remain the same and this will be their first home gm in 4 wks. In Provo, BYU 3-1 ATS and +28 ppg and +210 ypg. Pass D #5 with 8-12 ratio which sets up well with pass-happy TCU in town. Even at 6-3, Frogs have disappointed. They're 0-2-1 ATS last 3 on road and just squandered gm to Iowa St, 20-17, that they had +160-yd edge. TCU solid vs the run (125, 3.3) but pass D has given up 18 td passes. BYU will hunker down on D and attack TCU with QB Bear Bachmeier and healthy RB LJ Martin (824, 5.8). Cougars tend not to blow teams out. But off a loss and against a TCU that's had its Big 12 title hopes burst, Cougars will earn a DD bounceback win.

ARIZONA ST by 17 over West Virginia - RichRod returns to the desert where he faced ASU 6 times as Arizona's HC (2-4 SU & ATS). West Virginia beat Houston & Colorado in b2b gms to remain alive for a bowl at 4-6. The offense has improved around true frosh QB Scotty Fox (5-4 ratio) and RB Diore Hubbard. However, the defense has not handled mobile QBs well this ssn, and Arizona St's Jeff Sims rushed for 228 yds in upset of Iowa St before last weekend's bye. Mountaineers' other big hurdle will be an underrated Sun Devil defense holding opponents 113 ypg below their average (#7 FBS). Only one team has scored more than 24 pts on them, and they are +129 ypg in Tempe. Rested ASU ends WVU's bowl hopes Sims' legs and stout defensive play.

MISSOURI ST by 1 over Ute - First mtg. UTEP only has two wins but they were within 3 LW against Jax St. MSU has reached 6 wins in their first year playing in the FBS. LW they trailed 10-0 2Q at Liberty but won 21-17. MSU is +2 ypg vs CUSA while UTEP is -55. MSU has had 8 straight games go Under the Vegas Total. UTEP is putting up 84 ypg less than their foes allow on avg while MSU is putting up 26 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. Bears are laying 7 which is the most they've laid against an FBS foe and we expect another low scoring, close game.

FRESNO ST by 1 over Wyoming - Fresno 4-1 SU & ATS last 5 in series. Bulldogs allowed just 34 pts in those gms. Fresno 6-3 and off best AGG of yr (116.6) in 30-7 upset at Boise St. Win keeps Bulldogs in MWC race. Offense avg just 225 yds last 2 gms and QB's have 10-11 ratio. However, D has only had 1 bad gm and holds opp's 51 ypg below their avg (#35 FBS). FSU has 16 takeaways and allows 3.9 ypc. Wyoming will struggle with this D and avg just 19ppg and 15ppg on road. They've gained less yds than opp D's avg 7 str gms. They've also turned ball over 16 times which is a situational edge for Fresno. Bulldogs win TO battle and ride the wave of the Boise St upset to a hard-fought, low-voltage win.

USC by 10 over Iowa - 1st reg szn meeting since '76 (Iowa lost at Coliseum, 55-0). Hawkeyes lost at UCLA (+6) 20-17 last year in first WC trip since '19 Holiday Bowl vs USC. Both teams entered LW in playoff contention. USC was 6-2 and off a big road win vs Nebraska. They did handle Michigan at home 31-13. The losses were at Illinois and ND. LW USC defeated Northwestern at home, 38-17 (-13). QB Maiaiva is hitting 66% with a 17-6 ratio. Iowa was also 6-2 with losses by 3 to Iowa St and by 1 to Penn St. LW Iowa lost to Oregon 18-16 (+4) on a FG w/ :03 left. USC is +100 ypg in B10 play and Iowa is +38. First 2 years in B10, Trojans are 6-1 SU & ATS in league

WASHINGTON by 21 over Purdue - Boilers trail 7-2-1 in series. Last 2 meetings in bowls (UW won '01 Rose; Purd won '02 Sun). 1st trip to Seattle since '89 (lost 38-9 as 21pt dog). 2nd WC trek last 15 years (lost LY at Oregon St, 38-21). First reg season meeting since '90. Huskies are on a 24-1 SU run at home. Washington opened 6-2 SU & 4-4 ATS but were just +5 ypg in Big Ten play. LW, Washington was upset by Wisconsin 13-10 (-10'). Purdue opened the year 2-0 vs non P4 teams but is now 0-8 vs P4 teams. LW Purdue lost to Ohio St 34-10 (+30'). QB Browne is hitting 61% with a 9-7 ratio but top RB Mockabee is OFY (521, 4.2). Since 2018, UW is 22-20-1 ATS as a home favorite (8-2 last 2 year & 6-0 vs B10). Purdue is on 4th road game in 6 weeks. We like the Huskies here.

WKU by 10 over Middle Tennessee - This is the 75th edition of the 100 Miles Of Hate rivalry. WKU has won 6 straight meetings and they've covered the L/4. 'Toppers are 7-2 SU/ATS and are fresh off a bye. They are +4 ppg/+20 ypg vs CUSA and 3 of their conf wins are by 5 pts or less. MT is a snake-bitten team, just 1-8 SU/4-5 ATS but are +16 ypg vs CUSA. The Blue Raiders lost at home to FIU 56-30 prior to their bye but were only outgained 401-364. QB Vattiato has a 16-7 ratio. WKU is laying almost 2 td's but MT tends to keep their games closer.

San Jose St by 11 over NEVADA - SJ St's first road trip in 4 wks. At 3-6, Spartans need this gm to remain in bowl hunt. They're fresh off a brutal loss to Air Force in which they were +133 yds but -3 TO's. And they have yet to win a road gm. However, SJ St has the substantially better offense led by QB Walker Eget (17-5 ratio). Plus, their defensive shortcomings are unlikely to get exposed this wk in Reno. Nevada is 0-8 vs the FBS and just played their worst gm of the ssn, a 51-14 loss to Utah St (-280 yds & 67.0 AGG). The offense has been held below 300 yds in 5 straight gms and gains 82 ypg below opp avg (#129 FBS). With the greater sense of urgency and far more offensive firepower, Spartans will race past Nevada to earn their first road win of the year.

TENNESSEE by 49 over New Mexico St - Vols are fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they out-gained OK 456-351. The Vols are 5-1 ATS under Heupel when favored by 40+ including a 72-17 win over ETSU. The Vols are also 10-5 ATS off a SU loss. NMST is 6-11 ATS vs P4 teams while Vols are 18-5 ATS as a HF. Vols have two quality backup QB's in Merklinger and McIntyre who will both see action and Heupel will let them run the offense so we expect no mercy, with a late td or two.

FIU by 1 over Liberty - Liberty is 4-5 SU/3-6 ATS and their chances of making the CUSA Title gm were extinguished LW when they blew a 10-0 lead and lost to Missouri St 21-17 (-7). FIU is also 4-5 SU/ATS and they will be thrilled to just make a bowl gm. LW FIU beat Middle Tenn 56-30 but only had a 401-364 yd edge. Liberty is -3 but they are 2-6 ATS as an AF while FIU is 14-10-1 as home dogs and a win here gives them a great shot at a bowl so we call for a small upset.

UNLV by 7 over Utah St - Both tms peaking and coming off their highest AGG's of the yr. UNLV snapped 2-gm skid by hammering Colorado St 42-10, while allowing ssn-low 292 yds. The 7-2 Rebs have scored at least 30 pts in every gm and gain 73 ypg above opp avg (#25 FBS). However, before last wk, they had allowed the last 3 opp to gain at least 146 yds above the norm. Utah St models Rebs, though they've played the tougher sked. Aggies average 34 ppg but allow opp 48 ypg above their avg (#115 FBS). And they're winless on the road, though the losses were to Texas A&M, Vandy, Hawaii & New Mexico. We expect a shootout, with UNLV having an edge on the ground. Rebels come out on top but there'll be multiple lead changes and it'll be close throughout.

WASHINGTON ST by 3 Louisiana Tech - First meeting. Cougars are 2-8 SU but 4-6 ATS off a bye s/'19. Both teams can still become bowl eligible. LT is 5-4 SU & 6-3 ATS but are just 1-3 SU & ATS L/4. WSU is 4-5 SU & 5-4 ATS incl 2-3 SU & 4-1 ATS L/5. Bulldogs are just 3-20 SU on the road & LW had a long trip to NE losing at Delaware 25-24 (-6) & are now traveling to the NW (combined 3400 miles). LT has a big edge on ST (#9-94) but WSU has edge on Def (#32-#96). LT is 2-2 SU & ATS on the road but easily covered at LSU 23-7 (+37) their only other time as a road dog this year. WSU is 3-1 SU & 2-2 ATS at home this year (1-1 as HF) but their avg score at home is 25-22. So while we expect the Cougars to win, we will take the over a td & the Bulldogs

SAN DIEGO ST by 5 over Boise St - MWC leaders square off in a poss preview of next month's title gm. Both looking to rebound from blowout losses. SD St was cruising along with 6 straight mostly blowout wins before falling at Hawaii 38-6. Offense had 267 yds and the rock-solid D buckled. Still, Aztecs only give up 13 ppg and yield less than 3 ypc. This D is a tall order for Boise who lost its last gm to Fresno, 30-7, and lost veteran QB Maddux Madsen to injury. Bronco offense has been inconsistent and now faces tough SD St D with a young QB. Boise D also terrific, allowing 92 ypg less than opp avg (#14 FBS), and will contain Aztec offense. SD St 4-0 at home by avg margin of 36-8. They'll reach 5-0 but it'll be a rock fight and we don't expect either to reach 20 pts.

4★ Baltimore over CLEVELAND – BAL's offense continues to find rhythm, avg 318.8 YPG TY, led by QB Lamar Jackson (176 yds, 1 TD LW) and RB Derrick Henry (20-75 rush LW). The Ravens have controlled this matchup, going 3-2 SU/ATS vs CLE with the Over 4-0, and they remain perfect 4-0 vs AFC North while 8-2-1 ATS after 150+ rush yds. BAL owns a +107 YPG and +9.2 PPG edge TY and has covered 6 of 7 when favored by 7.5+ vs CLE over the last decade. CLE's offense ranks near the bottom (265.1 YPG) with QB Dillon Gabriel again inaccurate despite 2 TDs LW, while WR Jerry Jeudy (6-78-1 LW) provided their only explosive output. The Browns' scoring differential sits at -9.9 PPG, and they're 1-8 ATS vs losing teams. BAL being on B2B Away games will be no problem as they are 3-1 SU/ATS in those spots. CLE D can only do so much and this BAL team is red hot, they'll roll here. **Forecast: Baltimore by 17.**

3★ Miami over Washington – This week's early matchup in Spain features a MIA team hitting its stride against a WAS squad struggling on D. MIA totaled 370 yds LW in a 30-13 win over BUF, led by RB De'Von Achane (22-174-2) and a balanced O directed by QB Tua Tagovailoa (173 pass yds, 2 TD, 2 INT). MIA O has trended upward past few weeks but TY sits at 299.3 YPG, 21.0 PPG. WAS remains vulnerable on D (394.6 YPG, 28.0 PPG allowed), and QB Marcus Mariota's (213 yds, 2 TD) output LW mostly came in garbage time of a 44-22 loss. With WR Terry McLaurin still sidelined, WAS lacks a vertical threat and has struggled to sustain drives. Trends heavily favor MIA — 15-5 ATS after holding opponents under 90 rush yds, while WAS is 0-5 ATS off a double-digit home loss. MIA is set to keep momentum against a struggling WAS team. **Forecast: Miami by 13.**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ San Francisco over ARIZONA – This divisional matchup sets up well for SF, who look to rebound after allowing 42 pts LW vs LAR. Despite QB Brock Purdy still questionable, QB Mac Jones filled in capably (319 pass yds, 3 TD, 1 INT) and led an O that totaled over 350 yds. The 49ers' O has consistently hovered near the top third of the league (356.2 YPG, 22.0 PPG) and should find success against an ARI D giving up 339.4 YPG and nearly 24 PPG TY. TE George Kittle (9-84-1) continues to be a key target, especially in red zone sets. ARI's QB Jacoby Brissett (258 yds, 2 TD LW) showed flashes but most of the production came after falling behind early, with TE Trey McBride (9-127-1) again serving as his go-to weapon. The Over has hit in 6 of the last 8 H2H meetings, but with SF 5-0 ATS after a DD loss and boasting the better trench play, they should control tempo on both sides. **Forecast: San Francisco by 10.**

OTHER PLAYS

NY Jets @ NEW ENGLAND – TNF – Week 11 opens in Foxborough as NE looks to stay hot while NYJ rides momentum from a 27-20 win over CLE. The Jets' special teams provided the spark LW, scoring 2 TDs, while RB Breece Hall led the O with 125 total yds. Still, NYJ's O remains inconsistent (285.6 YPG) and faces a top-tier NE D allowing just 19.2 PPG. The Pats continued their balanced surge in a 28-23 win over TB behind QB Drake Maye (270 yds, 2 TD) and RB TreVeyon Henderson (147 yds, 2 TD), pushing their record to 8-2 SU. NE has owned this matchup (7-2 SU/ATS L9) and is 6-1 ATS LT overall, though the Jets have covered five of nine this season. The Over has hit in six straight for both teams, but with NE's defense tightening at home, the scoring pace could slow under primetime pressure. ***Get the Thursday Night NFL Marquee online at ncsports.com or call the office at 1-800-654-3448 after 12:00 noon ET.**

Green Bay by 10 over NY GIANTS – GB's O was stifled by a tough PHI D in last week's 10-7 loss, as QB Jordan Love (176 yds) and RB Josh Jacobs (21-74-1) found little room against one of the league's top units. Facing a far weaker NYG D (383 YPG allowed) should help the Packers get back on track offensively. NYG meanwhile, fell 24-20 at CHI despite QB Jaxson Dart (242 yds) keeping them competitive, but with Dart still in concussion protocol and with HC Daboll TW even if Dart is back he will likely be limited running to avoid hits. NYG's limited passing attack faces a steep test against a GB D allowing under 290 YPG. H2H trends lean NYG (2-0 SU/ATS last five years), but statistical edges across both sides of the ball favor GB to bounce back, especially when you see NYG can't keep things rolling set at 1-7 ATS after an ATS win. GB takes care of business in this one.

Tampa Bay by 3 over BUFFALO – Two 6-3 squads square off in Orchard Park with both looking to rebound from losses. TB's O (328.3 YPG) held its own in a 28-23 defeat to NE as QB Baker Mayfield threw for 273 yds, 3 TD, and WR Emeka Egbuka led the way with 115 yds, 1 TD. BUF's potent attack (384.4 YPG, 27.6 PPG) struggled early in a 30-13 loss to MIA despite QB Josh Allen's 306 yds, 2 TD, and RB James Cook's 53 rush yds. TB remains strong situationally, going 13-3 ATS off a SU loss and 9-2 ATS on the road vs winning teams, while BUF is just 1-5 ATS after allowing 350+ yds. The Over is 11-1 in TB's last 12 following a 350+ yd defensive outing, and both sides have enough offensive firepower to test two middling defenses (TB allowing 334.0 YPG, BUF 317.8 YPG). Mayfield's efficiency keeps TB live as a road dog.

PITTSBURGH by 8 over Cincinnati – PIT looks to bounce back after a sluggish 25-10 loss to LAC, where QB Aaron Rodgers (161 yds, 2 INT, 1 TD) missed key throws and the ground game never found traction (RB Jaylen Warren 14-70). CIN comes off a bye, with QB Joe Flacco expected to return fully healthy, while Joe Burrow remains out despite returning to practice. The Bengals' D has been a liability, allowing 426 YPG and 33.3 PPG, fueling five straight Overs that've averaged 67 total pts per game. H2H trends favor PIT (3-2 SU, 4-1 ATS), and given the defensive mismatch and CIN's ongoing struggles on the road, the Steelers are well-positioned to rebound while the Over remains firmly in play.

Houston by 13 over TENNESSEE – HOU rallied for a huge 36-29 comeback win over JAX LW behind QB Davis Mills (292 yds, 2 TD) and strong efforts from WR Nico Collins (7-136) and RB Jo'quavious Marks (63 yds, TD). Whether C.J. Stroud clears concussion protocol or not, this matchup tilts heavily toward HOU — their #1 D (261 YPG, 16.7 PPG) now faces a TEN O ranked last in the league (244 YPG, 14.4 PPG) and coming off a bye. The Titans are 0-8 ATS vs losing teams, while the Texans are 4-0-1 ATS in that same spot. With the numbers overwhelmingly in their favor, HOU should dominate the line of scrimmage and extend their H2H edge (5-1 SU/ATS) but if Mills is asked to come in again it will likely be a closer game.

MINNESOTA by 1 over Chicago – MIN fell to 4-5 after a 27-19 loss to BAL, where QB J.J. McCarthy (248 yds, 2 INT, 1 TD) showed flashes as a dual threat (48 rush yds) but turnovers stalled key drives. WR Jalen Nailor (5-124-1) was the lone standout for an MIN O posting 299.9 YPG. MIN D continues to hold steady at 317.2 YPG allowed, keeping them competitive despite inconsistent scoring. CHI improved to 6-3 after a 24-20 win over NYG, led by QB Caleb Williams (220 yds, 1 TD) and RB D'Andre Swift (13-80 yds). The CHI O has been impressive with 379.8 YPG and 26.6 PPG, but their D has struggled despite sitting at a league high +14 TO, they are giving up 375.7 YPG and 27.4 PPG. H2H favors MIN (8-1 SU), but ATS tells a different story — CHI is 6-2-1 ATS in those matchups, suggesting the market consistently overvalues MIN in this series. With both teams trending Over (CHI 5-0-1 road O/U, MIN 6-1 O/U TY), the numbers point to another high-yardage NFC North clash where MIN just edges out the win while CHI covers.

ATLANTA by 7 over Carolina – This NFC South matchup pits two inconsistent teams trying to stay afloat in the playoff picture. CAR's O sputtered LW, posting just 177 total yds in a 17-7 loss to NO as

QB Bryce Young struggled for 124 yds, 1 INT, while RB Rico Dowdle provided their lone TD on the ground. ATL pushed IND to OT before falling 31-25, with QB Michael Penix Jr. throwing for 177 yds, 1 TD, RB Bijan Robinson rushing for 84 yds, and WR Drake London tallying 104 yds, 1 TD. CAR has gone 4-0 ATS off a SU loss and owns the H2H edge (4-2 SU/ATS), but ATL's O (330.8 YPG) has been moving the ball well and should find success against a CAR D allowing 323.7 YPG. The Over is 9-1 in CAR's last 10 after scoring under 15 pts showing how well they bounce back but ATL is coming off games vs NE and IND where they narrowly got beat by 1 and 6 points. ATL D has an edge here with +5 TO against CAR -5 TO and that will make the difference here.

LA Chargers by 7 over JACKSONVILLE – LAC enters off a 25-10 win vs PIT where QB Justin Herbert stayed efficient (220 yds, 1 TD) and RB Kimani Vidal paced the ground game (25-95-1) while WR Ladd McConkey added a 107-yd TD. The Chargers' O (368.5 YPG) continues to move the ball well, backed by a D allowing only 280.2 YPG. JAX was out-gained badly in a 36-29 loss at HOU, finishing with just 213 total yds; QB Trevor Lawrence struggled (158 yds, 1 TD, 1 INT) and RB Travis Etienne had limited impact (16-58-1). Season metrics lean LAC (-64 YPG edge) with JAX's D yielding 344.6 YPG and the team mired in an 0-4 ATS skid. The Over 4-0 in this series suggests points. LAC's steady yardage and turnover profile give them the analytical edge with their D only allowing 280.2 YPG they should win this one.

LA RAMS by 4 over Seattle – Both clubs enter 7-2 SU/ATS, but LAR hold the upper hand with dominance in this series — 8-1 ATS last 9 H2H — and they're 5-0 ATS following a win of 14+ pts, showing they sustain momentum. QB Matthew Stafford (280 yds, 4 TD LW) and RB Kyren Williams (73 yds, 2 TD) pilot an O averaging 373 YPG, while their D has kept foes under 20 PPG in 4 of 5. SEA, fresh off a 44-22 rout of ARI behind RB Zach Charbonnet (83 yds, TD) and WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba (93 yds, TD), bring a top-10 offense into a stiff test vs a LAR D allowing just 17 PPG. The Under 4-1 in Rams home games suggests scoring could tighten late despite both offenses ranking top-10 in YPG. **Kansas City by 3 over DENVER** – Both teams enter with extra prep — KC off a bye (6-1 SU, 3-3 ATS under Reid) and DEN in a B2B home spot where they're 5-1 SU/ATS. This series has leaned defensive, with the Under 4-0 in KC's last 4 overall and 5-0 in DEN's last 5 vs AFC. Mahomes' O (370 YPG, 26 PPG) will be challenged by a DEN D allowing just 17 PPG and ranked top-3 in total defense (271 YPG). Bo Nix (150 yds, 2 INT, 1 TD LW) and J.K. Dobbins (77 yds) led a sluggish attack vs LV, but the defense held the Raiders scoreless for three quarters. With KC just 1-6 ATS vs AFC West, expect another tight divisional grinder where both defenses dictate tempo and that hook should mean the difference in the cover here and the under is the strong play.

Detroit @ PHILADELPHIA – SNF – Both teams enter primetime on a roll, with DET (372 YPG, 31 PPG) fielding one of the league's top offenses and PHI relying on a defense that's kept opponents to 21 PPG despite uneven offensive output. Goff (320 yds, 3 TD LW) and Jahmyr Gibbs (142 rush yds, 2 TD) led a dominant showing vs WAS, while Hurts (183 yds, 1 TD LW) and Barkley (60 yds) leaned on efficiency to grind out a low-scoring win at GB. PHI has covered 6 straight vs winning teams, and the Over has hit in 9 straight H2H matchups, including both recent meetings. DET's B2B Away spot (2-2 SU/ATS) adds intrigue in what shapes up as a strength-on-strength battle. PHI's disciplined D vs DET's high-powered O setting the stage for one of the week's most balanced matchups. ***Get the Sunday Night NFL Marquee online at ncsports.com or call the office at 1-800-654-3448 after 11:00am ET.**

Dallas @ LAS VEGAS – MNF – Both teams enter off extended rest, with DAL coming off a bye and LV having played TNF. The Cowboys' O (378 YPG, 29 PPG) remains one of the league's most explosive, but their D (397 YPG, 30 PPG) has been a liability. LV's O (273 YPG, 15 PPG) continues to sputter, though the D (321 YPG, 24 PPG) has kept them competitive. The Over (5-1 in DAL's last 6) and the Under (5-0 in LV's last 5 MNF) collide here, setting up a tempo battle between a rested Dallas offense and a Raiders defense that's quietly trending upward.
