4★ OKLAHOMA over LSU - LSU has won 3 meetings since '03. LY was their first SEC meeting and LSU won 37-17 (-6). That was an injury depleted Oklahoma team. This year the Sooners are a win away from making the playoffs. LSU is 7-4 SU but they are on a 0-5 ATS run. LW they were -22 vs WKU but only won 13-10. QB Nussmeier is a ? again and Van Buren was ineffective LW. The LSU Oline has struggled and face a nasty OK front 7 that allows 81 rush ypg (2.4) and has 42 sacks. They've been missing star DE R Mason Thomas the last two games yet still had 4 sacks in both. We just cashed our **5★ GOY** on Oklahoma LW, and the Sooners are clearly more motivated and laying just 10' at home. LSU looked puncheon LW and will have a hard time scoring on the Sooners D. Sooners win by nearly 3 td's for our Top Newsletter play!

FORECAST: OKLAHOMA by 20

3★ Smu over CALIFORNIA - SMU won LY's meeting 38-6 (-13) with a 415-254 yd edge. Cal's loss to Stanford was the final straw in the Justin Wilcox era. Former Hawaii QB/Wash St HC Nick Rolovich is the Interim HC. Cal is bowl eligible with 6 wins. SMU needs a win to clinch a spot in the ACC Title gm. LW SMU rolled Louisville 38-6, giving us an easy 4H LPS winner. After a 2-2 start, the Mustangs are 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS. They have wins over Miami and Clemson and they are +17 ppg at home. Cal QB JKS only has a 7-6 ratio in ACC play. Cal's best win is by a fg over that same Lville team that SMU smoked. Mustangs have the motivation edge and win by 3 td's.

FORECAST: Smu by 21

3★ HAWAII over Wyoming - Hawaii 3-0 ATS last 3 visits from Wyoming. Warriors 7-4 and coming off worst loss of yr, 38-10, to UNLV. But that was in Vegas and this is back on the island. At home, Warriors 5-1 SU & ATS and beating opp by 15ppg and 93ypg. They have a far better offense in this matchup, led by QB Micah Alejado (66%, 19-8) and rec's Jackson Harris (810, 18.0) & Pofele Ashlock (633, 10.9). Wyoming has dropped 3 straight to fall to 4-7. In those 3 losses, Cowboys scored 17 pts and avg just 12ppg on the road. The D has kept tm competitive, allowing 20ppg and holding opp 24ypg below their avg (#50 FBS). Hawaii HC Chang will have tm ready to rebound from last wk vs. weak opp. Wyoming can't keep up with the Warrior offense in a 3 td loss.

2★ PITTSBURGH (+) over Miami, FI - Both playoff and ACC Title game implications on the line. Miami needs a quality win to stay in the playoff race while a win by Pitt (and either an SMU or UVA loss) puts them in the ACC Title game. 'Canes are 8-1 SU/7-2 ATS at Pitt. Pitt is +86 ypg vs the ACC. LW they jumped on GTech with a 28-0 lead and won 42-28. LW we said Miami needed style points and ut 27-17 on VT they added a 20 yd td pass w/20 left. They've scored w/under 2 min left in 5 of their 9 wins this year. It's going to be a cold day in Pittsburgh with temps in the 30's which helps the home dog here and Pitt's D keeps it close. We cashed a 2H on Pitt on these pages LW and we are going back to the Panthers this week.

FORECAST: Miami, FI by 1

2★ Penn St over RUTGERS - Penn St has won 17 straight vs Rutgers & covered last 4 meetings. Last 10 games Lions held Knights to 10 pts or less. Last time here in '23, PSU (-20) got 2 4Q TDs for 27-6 win. Rutgers 0-14 all-time in NJ vs PSU. Rutgers opened 5-5. LW Rutgers went to the Horse-shoe and lost to Ohio St 42-9 (+28'). Since their 3-6 start, PSU nearly upset Indiana and they've won their L/2 by a combined 65-20 over Mich St & Nebraska. LW, Allen rushed for 160 yards and became Penn St's all-time leading rusher, leading to 37-10 win over Nebraska (-7). Penn St is -92 ypg in Big Ten play and Rutgers is -58 ypg. RU 0-6 SU & ATS last 6 home finales & Schiano since returning is just 3-13-1 ATS as a B10 HD, with Penn St 10-3 ATS as an AF the last 4 years. We like PSU to control the LOS and gash Rutgers poor run D that allows 202 (6.6).

Navy at Memphis - It's a Turkey Day matchup with AAC Title game implications. Navy needs to win this game and have either Tulane or North Texas lose. Memphis looked like a possible playoff team when they were 6-0 but they've lost 3 of their last 5. The Tigers won 5 straight vs Navy from '19-'23 but lost LY 56-44 (-9') despite putting up 659 yards. Memphis does get extra rest to prep for the option. Their D is allowing 483 ypg and they've allowed 484 ypg in their L/6. Navy is #128 on our Pass D Rankings. Navy is 9-4 ATS as an AF while Memphis is 12-3 as a home dog. Call 1-800-654-3448 or goto NCSSports.com for our Thanksgiving Day Exec.

Friday November 28th

BUFFALO by 1 over Ohio - Ohio is 5-1 SU & ATS vs UB s/'18. LY Ohio (-5)won 47-16. LW UB (+2') lost 37-20 hosting Miami knocking UB out of MAC race but need a win here to be bowl eligible. LW Ohio (-33) only led UMass 21-14 3Q but won 42-14 to stay in MAC race. Bobcats are 5-2 SU but 3-4 ATS in MAC play incl 1-2 SU & 0-3 ATS on MAC road. Bulls are 4-3 SU but 1-6 ATS incl just 1-2 SU & 0-3 ATS in MAC HG's. Vs 4 common foes Ohio is 4-0 SU & 2-2 ATS winning by an avg 32-19 with a 414-310 yd edge, UB is 3-1 SU but 1-3 ATS winning by an avg 27-23 with a 374-329 yd edge. HT is 13-2 SU & 12-3 ATS. Ohio' has just a combined 98 yd pass their L/2 gm (290 ypg rush L/2) but are avg just 4.4 ypg on road while UB is holding foes to 143 ypg rush (3.5).

Ohio can still make MAC Championship but would need a lot of help. Look for UB to keep it close.

Ole Miss by 7 over MISSISSIPPI ST - The Lane Kiffin saga has yet to be resolved which has to be a distraction in the Ole Miss locker room. Ole Miss has won their last 4 but two weeks ago they were only up 3 on Florida until a late td put the game out of reach. Miss St can still reach a bowl and they'd love to play spoiler. Blake Shapen will return as st'g QB for Miss St. His best game was at home vs Texas (381, 4 td's). If they get that version of Shapen then there's potential for an upset. Miss St's 22 pt loss at Mizzou is misleading (only trailed 21-17 mid 3Q then 2 Def td's). The Under is on an 8-0 run and the home team is just 0-9-1 ATS in the Egg Bowl. We still lean with the Bulldogs here as things in Oxford are getting more awkward by the day.

Iowa by 3 over NEBRASKA - Rivalry played every year since '11. Iowa has won 9 of last 10 (5-4-1 ATS). Iowa has also won last 6 in Lincoln (5-1 ATS). Home team 0-4-1 ATS last 5. Iowa won last 12 B10 road finale (12-0 SU & 11-1 ATS). Since '11, Huskers 0-6 SU & 1-5 ATS in Lincoln. Last 2, Iowa won by identical 13-10 scores. LY Huskers led 10-0 & outgained Iowa 334-164 but still lost. Iowa opened 6-2, only losing to Indiana by 5. LW, Iowa used a Stevens FG with :00 left to defeat Michigan St 20-17 (-17'). QB Gronowski is hitting 64% with a 6-5 ratio and the D is holding foes to 119 ypg below their average. Nebraska also opened 6-2 and led USC 14-6 when QB Raiola was OFY. They lost 21-17 at home, ending playoff chances. LW, Nebraska went to Happy Valley & left with a 37-10 loss to Penn St (+7). Dog is 6-0-1 ATS in series. Vegas has Iowa -6. We think Nebraska keeps it within a FG.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 2 over Kent St - NIU's last MAC game as they move to MWC after season. NIU is 12-1 SU & 8-5 ATS vs Kent St with the only SU loss being in '21 reg ssn, but NIU got revenge for it winning the rematch in the '21 MAC Championship. Last met '23, NIU (-19') only won 37-27. Both will be home for bowl ssn with KS 4-7 SU & 6-5 ATS while NIU is 3-8 SU & ATS. Flashes

are 3-4 SU & 4-3 ATS in MAC play incl 1-2 SU & ATS on road, Huskies are 2-5 SU in MAC play incl 1-2 SU & ATS at home. Only 3 common foes KS is 1-2 SU & ATS being outscored by an avg 23-22 score being outgained 354-285. NIU is 2-1 SU & ATS winning by an avg 23-17 with a 335-327 yd edge. We look for NIU to go out on a winning note but Kent St should be able to keep it close.

Utah by 17 over KANSAS - Utah can still make Big 12 title gm and earn CFP berth but needs a win here and help. Utes reached 9-2 with a wild comeback win over K-State. With a healthy Devyn Dampier (19-5, 637 rush), offense on a tear with at least 45pts 4 straight gms. Utes gaining 127ypg above opp avg (#7 FBS). But run D has shown holes and just allowed 472yds to KSU! A rough 2nd half (1-4 SU & ATS last 5) has Kansas still needing one win for bowl eligibility. Jayhawks allow 21 ypg above opp avg (#90 FBS) and rank 98th in pass D. KU will have an even bigger problem slowing Utah ground gm that's #2 in FBS at 280ypg (6.2) and mixing in backup QB Byrd Ficklin (496, 9.2, 10 td's). Utes have too much offense for Jayhawks to pull the upset here.

ARIZONA ST by 3 over Arizona - 99th Territorial Cup. Home tm 1-5 ATS last 6 mtgs. Both tms 8-3 with a shot at 10-win ssn. ASU still in Big 12 title hunt but needs a lot of help. Sun Devils have played very well since losing QB Sam Leavitt. They've rallied around the backfield of QB Jeff Sims (10-3 ratio, 423 rush) and RB Raleek Brown (1,078, 6.2). Plus, the D has been solid all yr, allowing 86ypg below opp avg (#16 FBS). Arizona is having a breakout Year 2 for HC Brent Brennan. Cats have won 4 straight incl 2 on the road. QB Noah Fifita has a 25-5 ratio and the pass D ranks #1 with 9-16 ratio. But beating revamped ASU requires stuffing the run and Arizona is a little more vulnerable in run D. Sun Devils leverage homefield edge to win thrilling seesaw battle.

Air Force by 8 over COLORADO ST - Home tm 0-8 ATS since '16, and AF has won 4 straight in Fort Collins. Both tms wrapping up very disappointing yrs. At 3-8, Falcons will miss b2b bowls for 1st time since '17/'18. The D has held last 2 opp 100+yds below their norm, and has only given up 21ppg over last 5 wks. But the offense is in disarray without QB Liam Szarka and just had ssn-low 161yds in 20-3 loss to New Mexico. CSU is 2-9 and losers of 5 straight. They've been outgained in 8 straight gms and yield 73ypg above opp avg (#128 FBS). This is an instate rivalry gm but motivation will be hard to find. AF has the better D which will be the difference in this gm.

† Georgia by 17 over Georgia Tech - GT is 3-0 ATS in this series. This game is being played in Mercedes Benz Stadium. LY the Jackets were +17' yet led 17-0 at half. UGA rallied late, and won in 8 OT's 44-42. UGA has rebounded since their loss to Bama with 7 straight wins. Naturally they didn't cover LW laying 42' vs CLT but the week prior they beat Texas 35-10. GT needed to beat Pitt LW to reach the ACC Title game but they were in a 28-0 hole and a 100-yd Pick-6 ruined their comeback bid. The Jackets are +76 ypg on the season. Unlike LY, UGA is not a lock to play in the SEC Title game so there is no look ahead and the Jackets will have their full attention. Big edge on D here for UGA, allowing 295 ypg and QB Stockton has been impressive. Dawgs won't let this one be as close.

San Diego St by 7 over NEW MEXICO - Aztecs will host MW Champ Gm with a road win. But New Mexico is also in the title chase. The league's biggest surprise is 8-3 and winners of 5 straight for 1st yr HC Eck. At home, Lobos 5-0 but 2-3 ATS. UNM's strength is a D that's #2 in MW run D (106ypg, 3.2) and #1 with 29 sacks. Lobos have not won league title since '64, so this is one of their biggest home gms of modern era. SD St is the last MW tm with 1 conf loss. D is elite, allowing 12ppg, 3.1ypc and 53% in pass D. But offense is inconsistent and has been held under 300yds 3 straight gms. This is not an easy spot for the MW leader. But defense travels, and no MW D is better than SD St. It won't be pretty but they'll stall UNM in a low-scoring, conf clinching win.

Boise St by 7 over UTAH ST - Boise has owned series. Last 12, Broncos 11-1 SU & 10-2 ATS with 8 covers in a row. But the gap has narrowed, with Boise regressing and Utah St improving for 1st yr HC Mendenhall. Aggies' 3 highest AGG's vs FBS came in last 3 gms. Last wk, they upset Fresno for first road win and bowl-clinching 6th victory. Offense led by QB Bryson Barnes (18-4, 644 rush). Boise can still get to MW title gm but at 7-4 this is their worst ssn since '21. Broncos rebounded from b2b losses by beating CSU 49-21 with 533yds. But that was home and this on the road, where Boise is 2-3 SU & 1-4 ATS. Utah St has momentum, confidence and a 5-0 home mark. But QB Max Cuthforth is evolving and Boise's series dominance will continue with a 7pt win.

Indiana by 24 over PURDUE - In-state rivalry for Old Oaken Bucket. LY the Hoosiers snapped Purdue's 3-game win streak, 66-0, in most lopsided game in series history. Last time here in '23, Indiana (+6) blew 10-pt 4Q lead & lost, 35-31. Boilers have won last 2 at home ('21 & '23). Purdue 2-6 ATS last year as DD dog. Purdue has a better HC this year & is 3-1 as a DD dog this yr. In their last game, Purdue lost to Washington 49-13 with a 506-257-yd disadvantage. Indiana opened 9-0 SU & 6-3 ATS but barely got past Penn St on the road. Indiana only led Wisconsin 10-7 at half but won at home 31-7. QB Mendoza is a Heisman contender and is hitting 71% with a 26-5 ratio & the D is holding foes to 110 ypg below their szn avg. Purdue has played #16 sked, while Hoosiers sked is #56. Indiana does have the B10 title game on deck so will likely rest starters late as opposed to LY. Both teams fresh off a bye. Vegas has Indiana -28'. We like the Hoosiers by slightly less.

NORTH TEXAS by 28 over Temple - NT has won both mtgs vs Temple though LY it was only 24-17 (-11). Temple has fallen apart lately, losing 3 straight including by 31 vs EC and 24 vs Tulane, both at home. Now they travel to Denton where NT is 5-1 SU/ATS and +107 ypg. Mean Green have won 5 straight. LW they beat Rice 56-24 (-18). The run D is a concern, allowing 211 (4.9). Temple has rushed for just 98 (3.6) in their L/4. The Owls need to pull an upset to reach a bowl while NT just needs to win to clinch a spot in the AAC Title game. HC Morris just took the job at Oklahoma St but will coach the rest of the season at NT. Mean Green handle business and win big.

Saturday November 29th

Florida St by 6 over FLORIDA - The home team is 2-10-1 ATS in this rivalry that has lost luster recently. FSU will retain Mike Norvell and a win makes the 'Noles bowl eligible. Florida looked listless in the 1H vs Tennessee LW. They were outgained 190-1 in the 1Q and trailed 31-0 at half. FSU already beat one of the SEC's best when they knocked off Bama in the opener. At just 3-8, we can't imagine too many Florida fans being fired up for this game. FSU had a 383-286 yd edge at NCST LW but shot themselves in the foot. FL won't force mistakes and FSU wins by on the road.

Texas Tech by 18 over WEST VIRGINIA - Furthest north TT will spend Thanksgiving week in tm history. Red Raiders 9-1 ATS last 10 off bye. At 10-1, TT nearing B12 title gm and playoff berth. Their only loss is to ASU and all of their wins are by 22+pts (+208ypg). WVU will finish RichRod's return ssn below .500. However, they're improving down the stretch. Last 4 gms, Neers beat Houston & Colorado and lost to TCU and ASU by 1 score (4-0 ATS). D has made big strides and has allowed 88 rush ypg (2.5) over last 4. This is WVU's bowl gm. This is a long trip the week before the Big 12 title gm for TT. Red Raiders win but for the 1st time all yr, it'll be by less than 3 td's.

OLD DOMINION by 31 over Georgia St - ODU 5-1 in series. Monarchs eyeing first 10-win ssn since '16. They're 8-3 and have won 4 straight since b2b brutal road losses to Marshall/JMU. ODU 5-0 SU & 3-2 ATS at home (+28ppg & +293ypg). Colton Joseph-led offense has gone over 500yds last 2 gms and gains 89ypg above opp avg (#16 FBS). Georgia St still looking for 1st FBS win. of their 10 losses, 8 are by DD. Passing gm has been accounted for 21 td's but D ranks 133rd against the pass and allows 73ypg above opp avg (#127 FBS). That porous defense has no shot of slowing down ODU. As Georgia St plays out the string, Monarchs roll to another lopsided win.

East Carolina by 10 over FAU - Two teams playing after their bubbles were burst LW. FAU put up 687 yds but lost to UConn 48-45 (+7). ECU needed to win out for a shot at the AAC Title game but lost 58-24 at UTSA (+2). Pirates are +85 ypg vs the AAC while FAU is -13 but the Owls are +81 ypg at home while EC is +91. FAU is -17 TO's this year. There's no harm in losing at UTSA so we still like this East Carolina team and FAU's games are swung by their frequent 4th down attempts. Pirates have the better D and they are more consistent so Pirates win by DD's.

TENNESSEE by 3 over Vanderbilt - Tenn has owned this series aside from a 7 year stretch where Vandy went 5-2 from '12-'18. The Vols have won 6 straight meetings. LY the Vols were playing with playoff pressure and trailed 14-0 1Q but controlled the 2H and won 36-23. Vols are off their first win in The Swamp since 2003. They led 31-0 at half w/a 323-110 yd edge. QB Pavia threw for a career high 539 yards LW and the 'Dores hammered KY 45-17. A win here puts Vandy in the playoffs and could give Pavia the Heisman. Tenn's Pass D is #90 (67%, 17-8). Vandy is on a 17-6-1 ATS run including 6-1-1 as away dogs and the home team is 0-6 ATS in the series but we can't go against the series history here so Vols win a close game.

MARSHALL by 11 over Georgia Southern - At 5-6, both looking to play their way into the bowls. After b2b road gms, Marshall returns home where they're 3-2 SU & 4-1 ATS. Herd off tough road loss to AppSt in which they were +162yds but -3 TO's in 2pt loss. Offense has been strong all yr, going over 400yds in 8 straight and avg 210yppg (4.8yppc) on the ground. On the flip side, Georgia Southern is 1-4 SU & ATS on the road and their defense is terrible. Eagles have allowed 400+ yds in 7 straight gms and the run D ranks last in the FBS (235yppg, 5.7yppc). The trio of QB JC French (17-8 ratio), RB OJ Arnold (880, 6.6) & WR Camden Brown (892, 16.5) can keep GS in this gm but eventually the dam will break and the Marshall ground gm will fuel a bowl-clinching win.

James Madison by 31 COASTAL CAROLINA - JMU remains class of SBC and a playoff contender so style pts will matter as they battle with the American champ. Dukes got their biggest challenge in wks and needed to rally to beat Wazzu 24-20. However, in SBC play they're +24ppg and +212yppg. The backfield of QB Alonza Barnett (17-6 ratio, 428 rush) and RB Wayne Knight (996, 6.4) is a big problem for the Coastal D. Chants have allowed 1,232 yds last 2 gms and allow 95yppg above opp avg (#132 FBS). Plus, against the 4 best tms on the schedule, Coastal has lost by combined score of 184-21. JMU has the offense and the rock-solid D to be the latest tm to manhandle the Chants. Dukes take a head of steam into SBC title gm with a blowout road win.

LOUISVILLE by 1 over Kentucky - UL ended a 5 game series losing streak LY when they won 41-14 (-4). Both teams are coming off lopsided losses. KY needs a win to reach a bowl. The 'Cats allowed Vandy QB Pavia to throw for a Vandy record 539 yds. UL was missing QB Moss and their top 2 RB's LW. The Cards were outgained 485-228 in a 38-6 (-4) at SMU. UL is +69 ypg while KY is -9 but the 'Cats have ply'd the tougher sked (#7 vs #49). The home team in this series is 3-12-1 ATS yet the 'Cats are getting just over a fg. UL wins a close game but KY covers.

USF by 28 over Rice - USF needs to win this game and get help to reach the AAC Title game. The Bulls are 8-3 SU/7-3-1 ATS after their 48-18 (-21) win over UAB. Rice is playing their first road game since October 11th. The Owls were no match for North Texas LW, losing 56-24 (+18). Now they play another high powered offense in USF. Two weeks ago USF lost at Navy 41-38 and allowed 338 rush (6.4) but Navy's offense is much more potent than Rice who only avg's 21 ppg/316 ypg. USF is laying 4 td's, the concern would be Rice limiting possessions but they aren't going to get many stops so we have USF right at the number.

Clemson by 4 over SOUTH CAROLINA - Clemson is out for revenge for LY's 17-14 (-2) home loss. LaNorris Sellers was a magician in that game but he hasn't been as sharp this year. SC blew a 30-3 lead at A&M 2 wks ago but LW didn't let up and crushed Coastal Car 51-7 (-24). Clemson has won 3 straight and are only off FCS Furman. At 4-7 with no bowl ahead SC is trying to send their Sr's out with a win but the home team is 0-7 ATS in this series and Clemson has won their L/5 in Columbia. None of SC's wins are against Bowl Eligible tms while Clemson beat FSU & L'ville. Tigers get their revenge as short underdogs.

Arkansas St by 3 over APPALACHIAN ST - Winner qualifies for bowl gm while loser's ssn is over. Arkansas St off b2b losses but both were 6pts or less. Red Wolves have won last 2 road trips at Troy and South Alabama. They have the more consistent offense and defense in this matchup, and are only -3ppg for the year. AppSt snapped 4-gm losing streak with last wk's win over Marshall, but they were -162yds and benefited from +3 TO's. Mountaineers have been outgained in 7 of last 8 gms and are just 2-3 ATS and -9yppg at home. Opponents have avg 6.0 ypc in 3 of last 5 gms which will create running room for Red Wolves runners. Arkansas St has the more seasoned HC and is making more stops on D. They win a close gm on the road to become bowl-eligible.

DUKE by 4 over Wake Forest - Duke has won 3 straight in this series, all by 6 pts or less. Duke's win over NCar LW was their 6th so they are bowl eligible. WF is the biggest surprise in the ACC at 8-3 and Jake Dickert is in the mix for ACC COY. They've won 3 straight, though UVA was w/o their st'g QB when WF upset them. LW they crushed Delaware 52-14 (-17) and put up a ssn high 577 yards. WF has a big edge on D (#15 vs #98) though NCar also had a big edge on D heading into LW and NCar still won 32-25 (-7). Duke is at home, has a much better QB in Mensah (3829, 67%, 31-6) and has ply'd the tougher sked (#50 vs #71). Duke squeaks out the home win.

Ohio St by 6 over MICHIGAN - Michigan leads all-time series 62-52-6. OSU is 3-8 ATS last 11 & have lost 4 in a row & 2 straight in Ann Arbor. Three of last 4 losses were outright upsets. Last time here, #3 UM (-3) beat #2 OSU, 30-24. HC Day 1-4 vs UM. After losing 14 of 15 from '04-'19, UM has won 4 straight for first time since '88-'91. LY's 13-10 shocker as 19-pt road dog kept OSU out of B10 title game. Buckeyes opened up 10-0 in mostly dominating wins. LW Ohio St - without WRs Smith & Tate - beat Rutgers 42-9 (-28'). This is 1st time since '73 that Ohio St will go into The Big House ranked #1 and unbeaten. Ohio St has 2 Heisman candidates in QB Sayin (81%, 24-4) & WR Smith. Michigan opened 7-2 with road losses to Oklahoma & USC. LW, Michigan #3 RB Kuzdzal had 100 yards in 45-20 win over Maryland (-14). True Frosh QB Underwood is hitting 61% with a 7-3 ratio & can be a dangerous runner. Vegas has OSU -10. We see the Buckeyes gaining revenge & remaining unbeaten, but UM covering.

MICHIGAN ST by 10 over Maryland - Since '14, Maryland 3-7 SU & 5-5 ATS vs. Michigan St. Terps 1-4 SU & 3-2 ATS in East Lansing, but this game is in Detroit. Last time here in '23, MD (-7) had 3 ints in 31-9 win. Terps have been outgained in 6 of last 7 meetings. MSU holds 11-4 all-time edge. Spartans 7-2 SU & 2-3 ATS at home in series but lost 31-9 as 7-pt dog in '23. LY, MSU (+8) won 27-24. In LY's final in the cold vs Rutgers almost the entire crowd was gone for the 2H of a dreary blowout loss. This year, Spartans moved their final game indoors to avoid that. Michigan St opened 3-0 SU but 0-3 ATS in non conf play. They then went 0-6 in B10 play but were the kings of the back-door covers. LW, Iowa used a Stevens FG with :00 left to defeat Michigan St 20-17 (+17). Maryland got off to an impressive 4-0 start including a big road win at Wisconsin. They blew 4Q leads vs Washington & Nebraska and fell to 4-5. LW Maryland lost to Michigan 45-20 (+14). Terps 5-15-1 ATS as B10 AD. Vegas has MSU -3'. We see them covering.

NC STATE by 3 over North Carolina - NCSt has won the L/4 mtgs but they are favored TY and they were the dog in the L/3. There will be no bowl for NC at 4-7. LW they led Duke 25-24 4Q but

lost by 7. NCSt is 6-5 but -77 ypg vs the ACC while NC is only -18. NCSt was outgained 383-286 vs FSU but +4 TO's and won 21-11. The underdog is 21-6 ATS with 16 upsets since 1998. The home team is on a 3-9 ATS run in this series. Series history says take the away dog, which points us to North Carolina (+7) and 3 of the L/4 have been decided by 5 pts or less.

Boston College by 5 over SYRACUSE - BC has won the last 2 in the series. LY BC won 37-31 (-2). This series has been dominated by the underdog who is 11-4 ATS w/9 upsets since '03. Neither team inspires any confidence. Since losing QB Angeli, Cuse is 0-7 SU/2-5 ATS and -135 ypg. LW they were down 21-0 at NDate before their OFF ran a play and lost 70-7! BC has lost 10 straight, but at least they've been competitive lately, only losing by 2 vs GTech prior to their bye last week. It's hard to lay points on the road with a team on a 10 gm losing streak but Cuse's QB situation is a mess and BC has covered 3 of their L/4 games.

VIRGINIA by 7 over Virginia Tech - Tables have turned in this series as VT is 18-1 SU but UVA is -10' and a win puts the Cavaliers in their first ACC Title game since '19. UVA is 9-2 SU/7-4 ATS and fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they handled Duke 34-17 on the road w/a 540-255 yd edge. VT is just 3-8 SU/ATS and LW they only trailed Miami by 10 when the 'Canes tacked on a td with :20 left. Hokies will play spoiler and Phillip Montgomery deserves credit for keeping them competitive despite the poor record. VT has been a dog twice in the last 6 years and won both outright, so VT keeps this one closer than expected.

Toledo by 12 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - UT is 13-2 SU & 11-4 ATS vs CM. LY UT (-14) won 37-10 but only had a 299-236 yd edge. Both are 7-4 SU & 8-3 ATS with UT winning & covering L/3 but are just 1-4 SU & 2-3 ATS on road. CM has covered L/5 (4-1 SU) & are 4-0 SU & ATS at home. Vs 4 common foes both are 2-2 SU. UT is 2-2 ATS with 32-14 ppg edge & a 452-222 yd edge. CM is 3-1 ATS with 25-19 ppg edge but outgained 332-297. Both are in MAC Title race needing to win & get help. Rockets are the more talented team but Chippewas will keep it close to the line.

MIAMI, OH by 20 over Ball St - Red Bird Rivalry. Miami is still in MAC Title hunt but needs to win & have the right dominos fall. Miami is 8-1 SU (incl L/5) VS BSU but 5-4 ATS (1-2 L/3). LY Miami (-1.5) led 27-21 4Q needing a SOD at M43 to hold on. Ball St is 0-3 SU & ATS on MAC road (-28 ppg). Miami is 2-1 SU & ATS at home with loss coming without starting QB vs UT. That starting QB has since left team to prepare for NFL. QB Masson started vs UT (11-38-147-0-3) but vs UB (0-2) was replaced by QB Gotkowski (13-23-185-1-0, 26 rush) who led the 37-20 win (-2) at UB. Vs 6 common foes Ball St is 2-4 SU & ATS (-13 ppg, -123 ypg). MU is 4-2 SU & ATS (+4 ppg, 46 ypg). Miami is 7-0 SU & 5-2 ATS in home finales. Look for the RedHawks to stay in the MAC race.

DELAWARE by 6 over Utep - First mtg. A 6th win gives Delaware a shot at a bowl if there is a slot available. The Blue Hens are +20 ypg in CUSA play but they've lost their last 2, by 3 at Sam Houston and LW 52-14 (+17) at Wake Forest. Blue Hens are 4-1 SU/2-3 ATS and +58 ypg at home. UTEP is -78 ypg in CUSA play and -70 ypg on the road. They've lost 4 straight and their two most recent road games were 13 pt loss at Kenn St and 14 pt loss at Missouri St. Delaware is laying 5 pts and we give a small lean to the home team.

UTSA by 17 over Army - UTSA is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS vs Army but the home team is 0-5 ATS. Playing on UTSA as a home dog in conference play was a no brainer LW when they beat East Carolina 58-28 (+2) to extend their streak to 25 consecutive home conference wins. The Roadrunners led 34-3 w/a 317-144 yd edge at half. Army was -10 vs Tulsa and led 25-14 but allowed 12 pts in the final 4:17 and lost 26-25. A win will make Army bowl eligible. UTSA shut down Rice's option earlier this year when they won 61-13. UTSA has outscored foes 127-25 in the 1H of their L/4 home gms. Army isn't built to come from behind and we will ride UTSA's home conference streak.

Alabama by 4 over AUBURN - The home team is 11-1-1 ATS in this series and Bama is 0-4 ATS when playing in Jordan-Hare. Bama needs a win to have a shot at the SEC Title game and would nearly clinch a playoff spot. A win here makes Auburn bowl eligible and they are off their two best offensive performances, putting up 38 pts/563 yds vs Vandy and LW 62 pts/547 yds vs Mercer. Bama is 3-1 SU/1-2-1 ATS and -4 ypg on the road this year. They trailed in the 4Q at SCar and lost at FSU. Auburn is +110 ypg at home. Bama hasn't gotten distance on any SEC teams and Auburn has the defense to stay close, plus the last 3 gms in Jordan-Hare were decided by 8 total pts.

TULSA by 11 over Uab - Two teams that are staying home for bowl season meet. Tulsa is off B2B wins, though they did trail at Army 25-14 before scoring 12 pts in the final 4:17 LW. UAB has lost 4 straight and now has to deal with the stabbing incident in their locker room prior to LW's game. UAB is only -21 ypg in AAC play but their last two losses were by 29 and 30 at home. Tulsa's HC Lamb still has his guys playing with motivation while UAB's staff and players will likely be looking for now homes soon so we will go with the home chalk by DD's.

KANSAS ST by 24 over Colorado - KSU needs one more win to become bowl-eligible and must bounce back quickly after brutal 51-47 loss at Utah. Cats blew late late but did locate the ground gm behind school-record 293yds from RB Joe Jackson. Jackson and athletic QB Avery Johnson now get to face Colorado run D that just allowed 355 rushing (7.9yppc!) to Arizona St and gives up 5.3 ypc for the ssn. Buffs have lost 4 straight (3 by at least 25pts) and the air appeared to leave the program in the 42-17 home loss to the Sun Devils. Now they'll finish the ssn on the road against a tm that just hung 542 yds on Utah and still has something to play for. KSU will build an early lead on the ground and put Colorado away in the 2nd half of a blowout.

TCU by 4 over Cincinnati - TCU looking to win its 6th straight home finale. Frogs rebounded last wk from b2b losses to beat Houston, 17-14, on the road. Their 526 yds were the most since the opener with UNC. TCU is 4-1 in Fort Worth with the only loss to Iowa St. While both tms are 7-4, Cincinnati is trending in a far worse direction. A Big 12 contender not long ago, Bearcats have lost 3 straight incl the last 2 at home to end conf title hopes. The defense has wilted, espec against the run, and now allows 32yppg above opp avg (#100 FBS). HC Satterfield is 4-12-1 ATS after a loss with the Bearcats, and they'll close out the regular ssn on the road with little at stake. TCU has the better D, more momentum, and is motivated to send the seniors out with a victory.

BAYLOR by 7 over Houston - Baylor is 1 win from bowl-eligibility, which matters to HC Aranda who feels a sense of urgency after the school announced he'll be back in '26. Bears got smashed in b2b losses, but outgained Utah 2 wks ago and were only -12 last wk at Arizona. QB Sawyer Robertson (30-11 ratio) keeps the tm in most gms and the maligned D has held 4 straight opp below their avg. Houston is 8-3 and 5-0 on the road (+12ppg/+99yppg), but their road slate has been soft and the tm has been trending south. Cougars have lost 2 of last 3 gms as a favorite to WVU and TCU. The D that was so good early on has begun to look vulnerable. This one is big for Baylor & Aranda. It'll show as the Bears use Robertson's arm and a stiffening D to hold off Houston.

SOUTHERN MISS by 10 over Troy - It's winner take all in the SBC West to see who faces JMU next wk. However, both schools are stumbling to the tape. Southern Miss, which led for much of the yr, has lost b2b gms to Texas St & South Alabama. Eagles were without QB Braylon Braxton vs Texas St, but even as he returned last wk they fell to the Jags. The D has allowed 449+ yds and has had just 1 sack in 3 straight gms. Troy has lost 2 of their last 3 and the D has given up 500+ yds in b2b gms. Neither tm runs the ball well and the Trojans gain 83 ypg below opp avg (#129 FBS). In his second gm back from injury, we expect Braxton (22-6 ratio) to return to form which was missing the last 2 wks. With QB settled, USM is ready to get back to beating opponents by DD.

Arch Manning has thrown for over 300 in 3 of their L/4 and he actually has a higher completion% and 1 less int than Reed this season despite facing a tougher sked. Aggies got behind 30-3 at half 2 wks ago vs SC and their win over ND earlier this year was on a late 4th and 11 play. We think Texas is the better team yet they are the underdog at home!

TEXAS ST by 8 over South Alabama - Texas St 5-0 at home vs USA (4-1 ATS). Bobcats 5-6 needing 1 more win for ssn-salvaging bowl gm. Bobcats have won b2b gms behind offense gaining 106 ypg above opp avg (#13 FBS). QB Brad Jackson has accounted for 29 td's and is improving as his 1st ssn winds down. The D, a liability early on, has held 3 straight below 400 yds. Despite being 4-7, USA is playing hard to the finish line. Jags have won 3 of last 4 and rarely lose big (avg score of 27-29 & +11 ypg this ssen). Texas St has outgained 7 of last 8 opp (one exception JMU) and the tm has finally learned how to close for HC Kinne. With a coveted bowl gm at stake, Bobcats will outscore USA in a shootout. But plucky Jags will keep this gm from getting out of control.

Fiu by 14 over SAM HOUSTON - LY SH was -4' and won 10-7 in a grossly unoffensive game. FIU has 6 wins and they have won 3 straight. SH started 0-9, won 2 straight but LW they lost 31-17 at Middle Tenn. The Bearkats are -160 ypg on the ssen and -102 vs CUSA. FIU just beat Liberty and Jax St in B2B weeks and also beat that same Middle Tenn team 56-30 on the road. Against 4 common foes, FIU is 3-1 SU/ATS, +7 ppg/+26 ypg while SH is 1-3 SU/2-2 ATS, -7 ppg/-129 ypg. FIU has things going in the right direction so we have them by 2 td's.

LOUISIANA by 7 over ULM - Louisiana has rallied for 3 straight wins to be in position to bowl with 1 more victory. Offense has scored at least 31 pts in each gm during streak, led by dual-threat QB Lunch Winfield who's one of 3 Cajuns with 500+ rushing yds. However, at home they're -11 ypg and the pass D allows 68% completions. ULM struggling in HC Vincent's 2nd yr. Warhawks have lost 7 straight and all 8 losses are by DD. The offense gains 91 ypg below opp avg (#131 FBS) and the D allows 33 ypg more (#104 FBS). ULM would love nothing more than to crush their rivals bowl hopes. They won't beat the Cajuns but it will be closer than expected. The road tm is 21-4-1 ATS in this instate rivalry and the dog is 11-4-1 ATS since '09.

Missouri by 1 over ARKANSAS - Ark is 1-8 SU in this series and Mizzou has covered 3 straight. The home team is 8-3 SU/9-2 ATS. Hogs put up 512 yards LW at Texas. Taylen Greene left w/a lower body inj but KJ Jackson came in and threw for 206 and a td. We cashed our 5★ GOY going against Mizzou LW in their 17-6 (+5) loss to Oklahoma. In the L/3 years, Eli Drinkwitz has 0 losses vs teams that finished w/ a losing SEC record. Ark is 0-7 in SEC play. Mizzou RB Hardy has had big games against weak teams and Ark had a 5 game stretch where they allowed 242 rush ypg. Hogs offense will keep this close but Mizzou gets the win.

TULANE by 28 over Charlotte - Tulane needs a win to clinch a spot in the AAC Title gm. The Green Wave have rebounded since their lopsided loss at UTSA with 3 straight wins. LW they were -8' and won at Temple 37-13 w/a 406-204 yd edge. CLT is 1-10 SU and their only win was against FCS Monmouth. 49ers are -191 ypg vs the AAC while Tulane is +47. Tulane's biggest win this year is by 24 points yet they are laying 29'. Once they get a lead they could take their foot off the gas as they get ready for the conference championship game so we are cutting our line off at 4 td's.

Iowa St by 17 over OKLAHOMA ST - Iowa St has lost 7 of last 8 trips to Stillwater. But this is not a typical Okl St tm. Cowboys have lost 10 straight since beating UT Martin in opener. The offense avg just 14 ppg & gains 58 ypg below opp avg (#118 FBS). However, OSU has been more competitive in Nov. with last 4 AGG's being their highest 4 of ssen. Iowa St 7-4 with b2b wins over TCU and Kansas. The 38-14 win over the Jayhawks (+139yds) was their highest AGG since Wk5. Cyclones have been crushed by injuries but they've regrouped around new starters and have turned the corner. OSU has played well, but their top players and the entire staff doesn't know where they'll be in '26. ISU wants to finish strong and has the talent edge to outclass 1-10 Cowboys.

ILLINOIS by 8 over Northwestern - 119th meeting of in-state rivalry played each year since 1927. NW won 8 of 9 from '12-'20, but have lost 3 of last 4. SU winner 8-2 ATS last 10. Last time here Cats won, 45-43, to end Illinois' bowl eligibility hopes. Illini have held "Land of Lincoln Trophy" 3 times last 4 years (3-1 ATS) after losing 6 straight from '15-'20. LY at Wrigley Field, Illinois defeated NWestern, 38-28. This year, Illinois lost to Indiana, Ohio St & Washington & fell to 6-3. LW, the Illini were upset by Wisconsin at Camp Randall, 27-10 (-9'). Northwestern was off to a 5-2 start but lost at Nebraska by 7 & at USC by 21. LW, Northwestern got an Olsen FG w/ :53 left to beat Minnesota, 38-35 (-4). QB Stone is hitting 59% with a 11-9 ratio. Wildcats are 25-16 ATS as an AD. Illini HC Bielema was 6-11-1 ATS as a HF here but is 4-0 ATS this yr. Vegas has Illinois -7. We like the Illini to win at home.

Wisconsin by 3 over MINNESOTA - 135th edition of the most played rivalry in major CFB. Battle for Paul Bunyan's Axe deadlocked at 63-63-8. Badgers 9-1 SU & 7-3 ATS in last 10 meetings on road ('21). Last time here Wisconsin (-2) had two 3Q TDs to win 28-14. After losing 14 straight from '04-'17, Minn has won 4 of last 7. LY, Minny led on the road 14-0 at half & won 24-7, dealing Wisconsin its 1st losing season in 22 yrs. Minnesota opened 6-3 but had just 1 impressive win - beating Nebraska at home 24-6. LW, Minnesota fell to Northwestern, 38-35 (+4) on a last-minute FG. Wisconsin once again lost their starting QB early &, by the time they played Washington, were down to a 4th string QB but pulled the upset to end a 6-game losing streak! LW, Wisconsin upset #21 Illinois at home, 27-10 (+9'). Vegas has Minnesota -1'. Home team has lost 3 straight & is 1-9-1 ATS since '15, so we're going with the Badgers here.

Louisiana Tech by 3 over MISSOURI ST - First mtg for new CUSA foes. LT's win over Liberty last week made them bowl eligible. QB Baker was out but bkp Kukuk ran for 143. MSU has 7 wins and is bowl eligible if a spot opens up. The Bears are +34 ypg in CUSA play but are coming off a 41-34 loss to Kennesaw St. QB Jacob Clark has a 22-10 ratio. Five of MSU's 7 wins are by 7 points or less. LT has 5 wins by DD's and two of their losses were by 1 point each. LT is +2' and we think they are the better team so they get a 3 point edge.

JACKSONVILLE ST by 3 over WKU - WKU won this game LY 19-17 (-1) and the home team is 3-0 SU/ATS. Jax St has rushed for 292 ypg in the 3 mtgs. Both teams are 6-1 SU in CUSA play and the winner is clinched for the Title game next week. WKU has won their 3 CUSA road games by just 9 total points. They are -99 ypg on the road. Since joining CUSA Jax St is 10-1 SU/9-2 ATS at home vs conference foes. They are also 7-1 ATS as a home dog. We don't read much into WKU's close game with punchless LSU and we like the 'Cocks to pull the upset as 3 pt dogs.

NOTRE DAME

BYU by 24 over UCF - BYU 6-1 in last 7 home finales. Cougars need this gm to ensure spot in Big 12 title gm. In Provo, BYU 5-0 SU and 4-1 ATS, outscoring opp 40-12 with 200 ypg margin. LJ Martin (1134, 5.8) leads rushing attack that avg 201 ypg, while Cougar D holds opp 59 ypg below their avg (#28 FBS). UCF is 5-6 so they need this upset to bowl. However, Knights 0-4 on the road and are playing poorly in Nov. (0-4 ATS last 4 gms). Outside of Orlando, they're -22 ppg and -97 ypg. UCF is BYU's last hurdle to a rematch with Texas Tech and a possible Big 12 crown. Cougars also have a big location edge since Knights not accustomed to the elevation or cold weather. BYU will pound away at the UCF front and never trail in a lopsided and low-scoring rout.

NEW MEXICO ST by 8 over Middle Tennessee - NMSt has won the last 3 meetings including 2 in CUSA play. Both teams are staying home for bowl season. NMSt is 4-7 SU/6-5 ATS and they've covered 3 straight. MT is 2-9 SU/5-6 ATS, but they are +11 ypg in CUSA play while NMSt is -78. Both teams enter off a win. MT beat Sam Houston 31-17 while MT knocked off UTEP 34-31. Three of NMSt's wins have come at home. MT's offense has been more impressive since switching to Roman Gagliano at QB (58%, 4-0, 139 rush). We give NMSt an 8 point edge in the pillow fight of the week.

Fresno St by 9 over SAN JOSE ST - 88th Battle for the Valley. Fresno St 7-4 and off tough home loss to Utah St. Offense has struggled all yr. Unit gains 47 ypg below opp avg (#115 FBS) and QB's have just 12-12 ratio. However, D has been terrific, holding opp 54 ypg below their avg (#31 FBS). San Jose St 3-8 with 3 straight losses (29 pts & -10 TO's during streak). Spartans a mirror image of Bulldogs. While the offense gains 64 ypg above opp avg (#25 FBS) D allows 51 ypg more than opp avg (#122 FBS). But sliding offense will now be without QB Walker Eget who was hurt in last wk's 25-3 loss at SD St. Spartans will go with frosh Tama Amisone which reduces the production of top WR Danny Scudero. FSU will stifle SJ St offense without Eget to earn rivalry road win.

Notre Dame by 35 over STANFORD - Irish are 5-1 SU & ATS incl LY when ND (-22') only led 21-7 at HT but were up 42-7 into 4Q & won 49-7. HT is 1-4 SU & ATS in series. With no classes, the student section could be close to empty. Stanford is 4-7 SU & ATS coming off the upset of rival Cal 31-10 (+3) & are 4-1 SU 7-3-2 ATS at home incl an outright upset of Florida St 20-13 (+17'). ND has won L/9 SU (7-1-1 ATS) and are 20-5 ATS vs ACC foes. Vs 3 common foes (UM, Pitt, BC) Stanford is 1-2 SU & ATS being outscored 32-19 & outgained 420-290. ND is 2-1 SU & 1-2 ATS with a 29-17 ppg edge & 386-275 ypg edge. ND looks to be looking for style points to impress the playoff committee as their 70-7 win over Syracuse LW shows. Irish have big edges on Off (#8-82) & on Def (#2-44) and needing those style points look for them to show no Mercy.

USC by 27 over UCLA - Victory Bell at stake when USC & UCLA meet. Bruins trail 51-34-7. Last time here '23, UCLA (+5') was outgained 387-354, but got a defensive TD & rolled to 38-20 upset. USC has lost B2B home games to UCLA for 1st time since '95/'97. Home team hasn't covered since 52-35 Trojan win in '19. USC (-4') scored 10 pts in final 6:55 last year for 19-13 win in Pasadena (-4'). USC opened 7-2 & was in prime contention for a playoff spot & USC was +156 ypg on the year. LW USC lost to Oregon, 42-27 (+10'). UCLA opened 0-3 & after a 35-10 loss to New Mexico, HC Foster was fired. UCLA then lost by 3 to Northwestern and won 3 in a row including a stunning upset of Penn St. LW UCLA lost lamaleava in 3Q & lost to Washington, 48-14 (+10'). UCLA is -32 ypg on the year. Home team 0-5 SU & ATS last 5. USC is off a huge game but UCLA has nothing left and the Trojans won't hold back on Senior Day.

Oregon by 10 over WASHINGTON - Longtime border rivals meet for 118th time. Ducks snapped 3-game losing streak with LY's 49-21 win as 18-pt fav. Last time here in '23, Oregon (+3') fell, 36-33, on Penix TD pass w/ 1:38 left (6 lead changes). UW had lost 12 straight from '04-'15, but went 5-3 SU from '16-'23 (won '23 P12 CG). Huskies 0-3 ATS vs Oregon last 3 at home. HC Fisch 1-2 ATS vs Ducks (1-1 as Ariz HC, lost last year in Eugene). LY, Washington started Williams at QB vs. Ducks on the road (+18) & lost, 49-21. Washington lost to Ohio St at home, Michigan on the road & a big upset loss at Wisconsin. LW, Huskies defeated UCLA, 48-14 (-10'). Offense struggles vs. good D's. Oregon opened with lots of impressive wins but lost at home to Indiana, 30-20 and just got past Iowa on the road 18-16. LW, #7 Ducks held off #15 USC, 42-27 (-10'). Oregon needs a win to lock up playoff spot. Fisch is 10-1 SU at home with Huskies but Lanning is 12-6 ATS as an AF. Vegas has Oregon -6'. We like the Ducks to cover.

LIBERTY by 3 over Kennesaw St - This was one of the biggest upsets of the year LY when KSU was +26 and won 27-24. Liberty has lost 3 straight, all by 7 pts or less. KSU is 8-3 SU/ATS and +25 ypg in CUSA play. Liberty is staying home for bowl season and will finish with their worst record since '05. Despite the poor record the Flames are +69 ypg in CUSA play. KSU is the road favorite but Liberty has home wins over NMSt and Delaware and they get revenge for LY's loss.

WASHINGTON ST by 12 over Oregon St - Rematch of Nov 1st gm, when Beavers (+4) won 10-7 thanks to being +2 TO & a WSU missed FG as they were outgained 271-208. HT have won & covered L/5. Cougars still have bowl hopes at 5-6 SU & 7-4 ATS incl 4-1 SU & 3-2 ATS at home. OSU is just 2-9 SU & 3-8 ATS incl 0-4 SU & ATS on road. OSU has lost their L/2 outright both as favorite. Cougars have covered 6 of L/7 ATS. Both offenses have struggled (WSU #100-121) but Cougars defense has been outstanding (#22-82). In fact we won 4 straight underdogs with Washington St including winning a 3★ Late Phone Total winner (under 47) in their last meeting. Could we use this game again for our Totals GOY? Look for the Cougars to take their in-ssn revenge.

Unlv by 7 over NEVADA - 51st battle for Fremont Cannon. UNLV has won 3 straight in series. Rebels 9-2 and peaking at end of HC Mullen's debut. They've won 3 straight and last wk's 38-10 rout of Hawaii produced highest AGG of yr (120.1). UNLV avgs 37 ppg and has the far better attack, led by sparkplug QB Anthony Colandrea (21-6 ratio/528 rush). Nevada just 3-8 but has been plucky. Plus, they've beaten San Jose St & Wyoming last 2 gms with their 2 highest AGG's of the ssen. Offense ranks 128th in ypg but D holds opp 21 ypg below their avg (#51 FBS) and held Spartans and Cowboys below 300yds. RB Caleb Ramseur has rushed for 216 last 2 gms. UNLV has too much offense to fumble this gm. But Pack playing with the confidence to keep it within 1 score.

4★ SEATTLE by 24 over Minnesota – SEA brings a clear efficiency gap with 364.6 YPG and 29.5 PPG vs MIN at 282.6 YPG and 20.4 PPG, and the recent trajectory only widens it with SEA averaging 37.3 PPG across its last three wins while MIN has averaged just 14.0 PPG across three straight losses. LV MIN was overwhelmed at GB with QB J.J. McCarthy held to 87 pass yds with 2 INT while RB Jordan Mason managed 42 rush yds and WR Justin Jefferson 48 rec yds — and now that offense draws a SEA D allowing only 301.0 YPG and 19.7 PPG. SEA continues to cash both SU and ATS (8-3 each) and has been especially strong off wins and high-out games (4-0 ATS after gaining 350+ total yds and 4-0 ATS after an SU win), and the added layer here is QB Sam Darnold facing his former team after MIN beat SEA last year with Darnold starting, now he's on the other side. LW Darnold threw for 244yds 2TDs and continued to roll with WR Smith -Nijigba dominating, he had 8 Rec, 167 yds 2TDs LW. This SEA O is going to absolutely dominate.

FORECAST: Seattle by 24

3★ CLEVELAND by 3 over San Francisco – SF holds the higher season averages at 348.6 YPG and 23.4 PPG vs CLE at 258.5 YPG and 16.9 PPG, but CLE's trench profile flips the matchup after LV's 10-sack performance and a D allowing just 273.0 YPG. LW SF beat CAR but QB Brock Purdy threw 3 TD with 193 pass yds while RB Christian McCaffrey handled 24 rush for 89 yds and 1 TD and TE George Kittle led with 78 rec yds, continuing SF's volatility when passing volume climbs. CLE enters off a controlled 24-10 win with QB Shedeur Sanders at 209 pass yds 1 TD 1 INT, RB Quinshon Jenkins 47 rush yds 2 TD and WR Dylan Sampson 59 rec yds, and the HD angle matches trends (CLE 3-0 ATS as HD; SF 3-12 ATS after an ATS win; 1-5 ATS after allowing <15 pts). Historical series leans Under (7-0-1 since 1990) and supports a low-possession game with pass-rush impact high. CLE D is insane, #2 Total D, Pass D and Sacks by, CLE O spark with QB Sanders alongside this D will push them past SF and Purdy who doesn't seem right back from his injury.

2★ LA Rams by 17 over CAROLINA – LAR holds the efficiency edge with 358.4 YPG and 27.8 PPG vs CAR at 307.2 YPG and 18.0 PPG, and the matchup leans further toward LAR given a top-tier D allowing just 16.3 PPG against a CAR O that has failed to reach 20 points in six of its last eight. LW CAR lost 20-9 with QB Bryce Young at 169 pass yds 1 TD 2 INT while RB Rico Dowdle totaled 38 rush yds and 36 rec yds, leaving limited scoring margin against a LAR unit that just dominated TB behind QB Matthew Stafford at 273 pass yds and 3 TD with WR Puka Nacua 97 rec yds and WR Davante Adams 62 rec yds 2 TD. Trend profile also favors separation with CAR 4-11-1 ATS vs winning teams and LAR 6-0 ATS after allowing <15 pts and 7-0 ATS after rushing <90 yds, indicating a cover play even without run-game efficiency. With LAR carrying advantages in YPG, PPG, and TO margin plus a consistent finishing rate through the air, not to mention possibly being the best team in the league, Rams roll.

Green Bay vs DETROIT - Thursday – GB enters at 338.9 YPG / 23.9 PPG on O and 278.7 YPG / 18.4 PPG on D after a 23-6 win with QB Jordan Love at 139 pass yds and RB Emanuel Wilson 107 rush yds and 2 TD. DET sits at 378.5 YPG / 29.6 PPG on O and 312.3 YPG / 22.1 PPG on D after an OT win where QB Jared Goff put up 279 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT and RB Jahmyr Gibbs totaled 264 scrimmage yds and 3 TD. H2H shows DET 6-2 SU in the last eight meetings, while GB has taken the last two Thanksgiving ATS results in this building. Short-week results are strong for both — GB has covered 4 straight Thursday games, and DET is 11-2 SU as a Thanksgiving favorite since 1990. Both O units bring explosive-play capability, while both D units have been top-10 on third down over the past month, suggesting fewer long sustained drives and more outcome swings tied to red-zone and turnover situations rather than steady momentum.

Kansas City vs DALLAS – Thursday – KC enters at 376.0 YPG / 25.2 PPG on O and 293.0 YPG / 18.3 PPG on D off a 23-20 OT win where QB Patrick Mahomes threw for 352 pass yds with WR Rashee Rice posting 141 rec yds and RB Kareem Hunt handling 104 rush yds and 1 TD. DAL sits at 387.3 YPG / 29.1 PPG on O and 377.5 YPG / 28.5 PPG on D after a 24-21 comeback win where QB Dak Prescott logged 354 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT with WR George Pickens at 146 rec yds and RB Javonte Williams rushing for 87. Trend data shows strong KC short-week output with Mahomes 14-2 SU indoors and 4-0 SU/ATS in non-Sunday road starts while road fav on Thanksgiving are 25-1 SU since 2004, countered by DAL's 3-11 ATS Thanksgiving record. KC is on a 6-game Under run while DAL has hit the Over in 5 straight Thanksgiving games.

Cincinnati vs BALTIMORE – Thursday – CIN enters at 307.1 YPG / 22.5 PPG on O and 415.8 YPG / 32.7 PPG allowed on D after a 26-20 loss where QB Joe Flacco threw for 183 pass yds 1 TD 1 INT, RB Chase Brown ran for 107, and WR Andrei Iosivas led with 61 rec yds, but Flacco goes back to the bench with QB Joe Burrow returning as the starter and WR Jamar Chase back from SUS. BAL sits at 314.6 YPG / 25.0 PPG on O and 347.5 YPG / 23.7 PPG allowed on D after a 23-10 win where QB Lamar Jackson had 153 pass yds, RB Derrick Henry logged 64 rush yds and 2 TD, and WR Zay Flowers had 58 rec yds. Recent matchup metrics show BAL 4-0 SU and 5-1 ATS in the last six vs CIN with the Over 6-0, while Burrow is 1-9 ATS in his last 10 AFC North starts and Thanksgiving Night Unders are 12-6 since 2006. Burrow vs Jackson headlines this one with cold weather that may complicate things or play into production on 2 cold weather teams.

Chicago vs PHILADELPHIA – Black Friday – CHI enters at 369.6 YPG / 26.3 PPG on O and 362.8 YPG / 26.5 PPG allowed on D after a 31-28 win where QB Caleb Williams threw for 239 pass yds 3 TD, RB Kyle Monagall added 48 rush yds 1 TD and WR D.J. Moore had 64 rec yds 2 TD, going 7-for-13 on third down and 3-for-3 in the red zone. PHI sits at 303.6 YPG / 23.2 PPG on O and 340.1 YPG / 20.5 PPG allowed on D after a 24-21 loss where QB Jalen Hurts totaled 289 pass yds 1 TD plus 33 rush yds 2 TD and WR A.J. Brown posted 110 rec yds 1 TD. Trend profile shows CHI with a +16 TO margin and 4-0 ATS after allowing 150+ rush yds, while PHI is 30-4 SU with Hurts as a home favorite and 10-0 ATS after a divisional matchup since last season. Total trends now split — CHI is 4-0-1 to the Under vs NFC and 5-1-1 to the Under on the road vs winning home teams, while CHI road games overall are 5-1-1 to the Over.

INDIANAPOLIS by 6 over Houston – IND holds the stronger scoring profile at 384.0 YPG / 31.0 PPG vs HOU at 323.4 YPG / 22.1 PPG and comes in off a 23-20 OT loss where QB Daniel Jones threw for 181 pass yds 2 TD, RB Jonathan Taylor ran for 58 and WR Ashton Dulin posted 48 rec yds. HOU enters with 323.4 YPG / 22.1 PPG on O and 264.3 YPG / 16.5 PPG allowed on D after a 23-19 win driven by its pass rush, with QB Davis Mills at 153 pass yds 2 TD, RB Joquian Marks 74 rush yds and WR Nico Collins 55 rec yds. Trend profile favors IND with 7-1 ATS vs AFC and 7-1 ATS vs AFC South, while HOU is 1-4 ATS in its last five road games despite strong defensive showings. IND is the stronger side here with the offensive edge and matchup trend advantage.

TAMPA BAY by 3 over Arizona – TB comes in at 319.5 YPG / 23.5 PPG on O and 341.2 YPG / 25.8 PPG allowed on D after a 34-7 loss where QB Baker Mayfield exited early (41 pass yds 1 TD 2 INT) and QB Teddy Bridgewater finished with 62 pass yds, while RB Sean Tucker led with 42 rush yds and WR Emeka Egbuka posted 32 rec yds. ARI sits at 332.8 YPG / 22.5 PPG on O and 337.0 YPG / 25.7 PPG allowed on D after a 27-24 OT loss where QB Jacoby Brissett threw for 317 pass yds 1 TD, WR Michael Wilson had 118 rec yds and RB Michael Carter ran for 28 as the run game stalled. Personnel notes favor TB with QB Mayfield OUT but RBucky Irving trending toward return, while ARI is without RB Emari Demercado and WR Marvin Harrison Jr. Trend split shows ARI very strong ATS on the road (8-0 vs winning home teams) but TB 4-0 ATS after scoring <15, while totals lean Over through ARI angles. Bridgewater should be able to take care of business here.

NYJ sits at 281.5 YPG / 19.9 PPG on O and 321.6 YPG / 26.5 PPG allowed on D following a 23-10 loss where QB Tyrod Taylor logged 222 pass yds 1 TD 1 INT and RB Breece Hall led with 119 scrimmage yds. Personnel notes show WR Drake London OUT for ATL and WR Garrett Wilson Questionable for NYJ. Trend split is sharp: ATL brings strong Under angles (7-1 after SU win; 6-1-1 vs losing teams) while NYJ brings strong Over angles (8-0 vs losing teams; 7-0 after <90 rush yds), creating volatility rather than a clear total lean.
