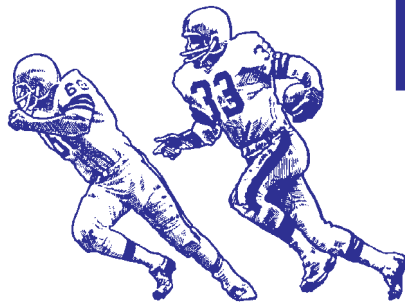

2025 COLLEGE TOTALS GAME OF THE YEAR WINS!!! GAME OF THE YEARS ARE NOW 3-0 100% THIS YEAR!!!

Four weeks ago our Small College Game of the year was Over 64' in the Mercer /WCar game and the final was 49-47 with 96 total points and the game was a winner in the 3Q! The Games of the Month for Small Colleges were a perfect 3-0 and our current Small College record is 31-15 67% the last 12 weeks! Two weeks ago we won our College Game of the year and had a winning week with the College Late Phone. In our 43 year history we are 31-13 on our College Games of the year. Last week we had our College Totals Game of the Year and it was on the OVER 53' in the James Madison Coastal Carolina game and James Madison went over that total by itself in a 59-10 win as we covered by over two TD's. We show you the box below on our big selections and they are now 11-3 over the last 3 years in the regular season!. Our College Totals Game of the year is 7-2 77% on this play the last 9 years. We are 3-0 on Games of the year this year. The NFL Game of the Months are now 6-2 over the last two years. The college Totals Game of the year was part of the Thanksgiving package and as always we did not raise the price on that package!

THANKSGIVING EXEC 47-18 on ★ BASIS '24 -Winning Week in '25

Way back in 1996 we had our first Thanksgiving Weekend Executive club weekend and had huge success. We priced it at just \$125 and that week there were only 35 College games on that Saturday. This upcoming Thanksgiving weekend there are 67 games and that does not even include Small College (FCS) which were not lined back then. We are superstitious and have kept the price the same each year and last year once again we hit 47-18 72%!! We will NOT discount that price ever as we have kept it at the same \$125 price for 30 years. Almost every Thanksgiving weekend has been a great success thru the years with most hitting 66% or better on the star basis. This past Thanksgiving was a winning weekend but not up to our normal standards. As mentions above we included our College Totals Game of the year in the package (\$100 value) and that play was an easy winner covering by over two TD's. We had a total of 15 star rated plays and they went 8-7 and on the star basis 28-23 56%. We did release 13 marquees which we treat as one star plays and they went 8-5. That makes the final tally for our Thanksgiving Weekend at 36-28 on the star basis for 56.3% which is good and did include a game of the year winner but we are a little disappointed it was not even better. The price for next yeas Thanksgiving Weekend will be the same \$125 as we do not want to mess with the great success it has had thru the years.

ACC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BANK OF AMERICA STADIUM - CHARLOTTE, NC

3★ ↑ Virginia over Duke - This is certainly not the ACC Title game anyone envisioned at the start of the season. Both teams are 0-1 in ACC Title games but they were both 28 point underdogs in those games. Duke and Virginia shared the ACC Title back in 1989 and Virginia also was Co-Champions with FSU in 1995. HC Tony Elliott felt this was by far his best team and they had a favorable schedule, missing Miami, Clemson, SMU, GTech and Pitt. Their loss to NC State was played as a non-conference game. Still, Virginia finished 10-2 and was +93 ypg vs ACC foes including a 34-17 beatdown at Duke where they had a 540-255 yd edge. Duke enters with 5 losses but 3 were non-conference. Duke also missed SMU, Miami, Pitt and they lost to GA Tech. Duke's defense has given up 423 ypg in ACC play. UVA QB Morris has a 14-7 ratio but Duke's pass D is #113, allowing 273 ypg and 68% completions. QB Mensah has a 31-6 ratio but UVA is #31 in our Pass D rankings, allowing just 203 pass ypg (58%, 13-12) and in the first meeting Mensah was only 18-35 for 213 yards and 1 td. If Duke wins this game then the ACC will likely get left out of the playoff all-together. Both teams had favorable schedules but Virginia has been playing better of late and their most impressive win all season was against this very Duke team. Duke will keep it closer but we like Virginia's D to be the difference in a 10 point win and save the ACC the embarrassment of having no team reach the playoffs.

AAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - YULMAN STADIUM - NEW ORLEANS, LA

2★ TULANE (+) over North Texas - This is the 4th straight year that Tulane has reached the AAC Title game. They beat UCF in '22 but lost in '23 vs SMU and LY lost 35-14 (-4) at Army. NT is trying to win their first ever FBS conference Title. This is their first conference title game since losing the CUSA Title to UTSA in '22. Tulane has won all 3 meetings since '13. Last year Tulane was -8. They led 21-3 2Q and 45-24 4Q. NT scored twice in the last 4:23 for a backdoor-push. The Mean Green are 10-2 SU/6-6 ATS and +81 ypg vs the AAC. They have home wins over Northwestern and Duke and their only losses were at Ole Miss and UTSA. NT is 11-1 SU/10-2 ATS and +130 vs the AAC. Tulane has faced the tougher schedule (#71 vs #106). The winner of this will get a spot in the CFB Playoff. Both NT's Eric Morris and Tulane's Jon Sumrall will coach this game and in the playoffs despite taking P4 jobs. Tulane has a big edge on D, holding foes 25 ypg below their avg and they've allowed just 1.6 ypc in their L/4. NT is #1 in the FBS, putting up 144 ypg more than their foes allow on avg but their D allows 30 ypg more than their foes allow (#99) and they have allowed 248 rush ypg (5.6) vs the AAC. We like Tulane who is 15-3 SU at home the last 3 years and a rare home dog.

CONFERENCE USA CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - AMFIRST STADIUM - JACKSONVILLE, AL

JACKSONVILLE ST by 4 over Kennesaw St - This is only Jax St's 3rd year in CUSA and they are already looking to win their 2nd Conference Title. They won the CUSA Title game last year, beating WKU 52-12. Both teams have first year HC's. This is a rematch of an earlier season matchup won by Jax St 35-26. KSU's 579 yards were a ssn high and the most allowed by Jax St all season. QB's Amari Odom and Dexter Williams combined for 362 pass yds but 4 int's and 3 were deep in Jax St territory. Last week we mentioned that Jax St was 10-1SU/9-2 ATS vs CUSA foes and they were the dog vs WKU. The Gamecocks pulled out a 37-34 (+2) upset and had a 515-384 yd edge. RB Cam Cook is CUSA's #1 rusher with 1,451 (5.8). QB Creel has a 6-3 ratio and is their #2 rusher with 830 (6.3). KSU allows 174 rush ypg (5.1) but just last week they allowed 291 rush (5.1) at Liberty. The Owls won that game 48-42 (-2). CUSA has been hard to get a read on this year. KSU is 7-1 SU/ATS vs CUSA but they were outgained in 4 of those wins and had the yardage edge in their loss. Jax St is 17-8 ATS since joining CUSA, they rarely lose at home and they have experience in this game so we like the Gamecocks to win a close game.

SUN BELT CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - BRIDGEFORTH STADIUM - HARRISONBURG, VA

JAMES MADISON by 28 over Troy - In just its 4th yr in the FBS, JMU hosts its first SBC title gm. These tms have not met in last 2 yrs. At 11-1, Dukes are the face of the conf with a chance to become 1st SBC tm to make CFP. They're a complete tm, with their only loss at Louisville, 28-14, in gm they led in 2nd half. At home, JMU 6-0 by a margin of 42-15 and +271 ypg. Offense ranks #6 in FBS rushing at 240 ypg (5.4) and is led by the combo of QB Alonza Barnett (20-7, 459 rush) & RB Wayne Knight (1051 rush/368 rec). In last week's 59-10 win over Coastal, we won our 4.5 star Total Game of the Year on JMU's pts alone. The D is elite in all phases, holding opp 136 ypg below their avg (#2 FBS). Dukes #5 in FBS run D (2.7 ypc) and #9 vs pass (50.4% allowed). Troy has been here before, winning '22 & '23 league titles, but that was with new Florida HC Jon Sumrall in charge. This is Gerard Parker's 2nd yr and first title gm. Troy rallied with b2b wins over Georgia St & USM to win West and is 4-2 SU & 5-1 ATS on road. Offense has gotten boost from return of QB Goose Crowder. In last 2 gms, Trojans have gone over 400 yds in b2b gms for first time this season while Crowder has had 7-1 ratio. Parker's D has been solid, allowing 244 ypg and ranking 3rd in the SBC with 29 sacks. Troy is a solid squad and Parker has done a nice job in Year 2. But JMU plays at a different level and will continue to do so even after HC Chesney announced he's taking the UCLA job. Dukes will shut Trojans down, roll by 4td's and then await word from the committee.

MOUNTAIN WEST CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - ALBERTSONS STADIUM - BOISE, ID

BOISE ST by 7 over UNLV - Rematch of last 2 MWC title gms and this yr's regular season matchup. Broncos won and covered all 3. In this year's meeting, Boise rushed for 294 yds and pulled away in the 2H of a 56-31 win. This is not the same Bronco team that went to the CFP in '24. They're 8-4 and just 1-4 ATS in last 5 gms. In their 4 losses to USF, Notre Dame, Fresno & SD St, they scored exactly 7 points in each gm. The offense took a hit after QB Maddux Madsen was lost in the Fresno gm, but he might play this week and backup Max Cuthforth just threw for 341 yds with 2-0 ratio in road win over Utah St. Broncos have the better D, holding opp 65 ypg below their avg (#25 FBS) and are +175 ypg at home and +80 ypg in MWC play. UNLV is 10-2 with 4 straight wins after dropping b2b gms midway through the season. After some misleading finals, Rebels are peaking late in the yr. Their 3 highest AGGs came in November including a 38-10 rout of Hawaii. The offense is in good hands with UVA transfer QB Anthony Colandrea (68%, 22-8, 555 rush). Defense is a weakness and allowed 558 yds to Boise in first meeting but has been playing better and has 20 sacks in last 5 games. Broncos are tough to beat on the Blue Turf, going 13-4-1 ATS as a home favorite last 3 years. And while they've won 52b titles, UNLV is still looking for their first conf championship. Rebels are improved so this will be closer than their regular season meeting. But Boise at home with the better D makes it 3 straight MWC crowns.

Saturday 12/6

BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - AT&T STADIUM - ARLINGTON, TX

↑ Texas Tech by 20 over BYU - Texas Tech and BYU meet for Round 2 and a chance to earn an automatic berth in the CFP. Red Raiders have been the frontrunner since conf play began. They're 11-1 with the lone loss at Arizona St when QB Behren Morton didn't play. Since then, they've won 5 straight by an average score of 42-7. All 11 of their wins were by 22+ pts including over BYU on 11/18 as 12pt favorite. TT held BYU to ssn-low 255 yds and just 67 yds rushing on 27 carries in the 29-7 rout. Red Raiders have a remarkable front 7 and lead the country in run defense at 69 ypg and 2.3 ypc. Both tms

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have been cover machines this yr, with TT 10-2 ATS & BYU 9-3 ATS. Cougars' loss in Lubbock is their only stumble this year. They're 11-1 but far less dominant at +16ppg and +88 ypg. On offense, BYU relies on the running of LJ Martin (1229, 5.7) and QB Bear Bachmeier (529, 3.9) But TT has held 6 of the last 7 opp to less than 100 yds rushing which will force true frosh Bachmeier to do more through the air. The D holds opp 61 ypg below their avg (#27 FBS) and is #8 in pass D with a 13-16 ratio. This is a solid all-around BYU squad but they're not quite in Texas Tech's league. Red Raiders are 21-6 as a DD favorite since '16 including 8-1 this season! Their balance on offense and their ability to negate BYU's ground game will lead to another lopsided win and a first round playoff bye.

MAC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - FORD FIELD - DETROIT, MI

↑ Western Michigan by 4 over Miami, Oh - This is MU's 8th MAC Title game (4-3 SU) incl their 3rd straight (won in '23). This is just WM's 4th Title game (1-2), their first since winning the Title in 2016, which had the Title games highest attendance ever (45,615). Miami is 7-5 SU & 8-4 ATS winning & covering L/2. WM after opening 0-3 SU (2-1 ATS) WM has won 8 of their L/9 going 9-3 ATS for ssn winning & covering L/2. Broncos went 7-1 in MAC play (only loss vs MU). RedHawks finished 6-2 in MAC play, tied with Ohio & Toledo, both teams they lost to but since they did not play each other, tiebreaker went to best record vs common foes and thanks in part to MU win over WM & UT & Ohio both losing to WM, MU won the tie breaker. Fifth time s/17, incla 3rd straight season this game will be a rematch from the regular season. In those previous 4 rematches, the SU winner of the regular mtg is just 1-3 SU in MAC Championship. In their reg ssn mtg at Miami, Broncos (+2) led 17-9 into 4Q before RedHawks led by QB Finn scored the final 17 pts finishing with a 408-316 yd edge. QB Finn after starting their next game vs Ohio, unexpectedly left the team. SR QB Hesson started vs UT (11-38-147-0-3) but FR Gotkowski has taken most of the snaps their L/2 (combined 25-47-411-4-0, 70 rush). WM QB Broc Lowry has started all 12 throwing for 1,507 (63%) with a 7-2 ratio but is also their top rusher 875 (5.0). Vs 5 common foes WM was 5-0 SU & ATS winning by an avg 28-13 with a 99 ypg edge. Miami was 3-2 SU & ATS winning by an avg 27-23 with a 58 ypg edge. We will look for the rematch trend to continue.

SEC CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - MERCEDEZ-BENZ STADIUM - ATLANTA, GA

↑ Georgia by 5 over Alabama - Georgia has played at least one game in Mercedes Benz Stadium each year since '17 and just beat Georgia Tech here last week. The Dawgs are playing in the SEC Title game for the 5th straight year and they are 5-7 SU/7-5 ATS all-time in SEC Title games. Bama is 11-4 SU but 7-7-1 ATS in SEC Title games. Bama has won all 4 head-to-head meetings vs Georgia in this game with the most recent coming 2 years ago when Bama won 27-24 (+5). The Dawgs were notorious slow starters early in the season and trailed 14-0 2Q vs Bama back in week5. UGA trailed 24-14 at half. They went 74/6 td 24-21 then reached the Bama11 in the 4Q but passed on a gm tying fg and were SOD. That was UGA's only loss this year as they've won 8 straight including a 25 pt win over Texas. Bama lost their opener at FSU then won 8 straight. They had a 406-212 yd edge vs OK but lost 23-21. LW they were outgained 411-280 at Auburn but recovered a late fumble and held on 27-20. Bama is +40 ypg vs the SEC while Georgia is +88. Bama has the edge on offense but RB Jam Miller is banged up again. UGA has the edge on D and ST's. Georgia is the favorite despite the loss in the first meeting and they've been coming on while Bama barely escaped vs Aub and SCar. Bama has had Georgia's number in this game but we think this is the year Georgia turns it around.

BIG 10 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME - LUCAS OIL STADIUM - INDIANAPOLIS, IN

↑ Ohio St by 3 over Indiana - Ohio St leads all-time series 81-12-5. Teams come in ranked #1 (OSU) & #2 (Indiana) - 1st time in B10 title history that both teams are ranked in the Top 2. It's 1st 1 vs. 2 B10 matchup since Ohio St beat Michigan, 42-39, in '06. This is Indiana's 1st B10 title appearance & 1st unbeaten reg szn. This is OSU's 1st unbeaten reg szn since 2012 & 11th overall. OSU has won the B10 title 39 times (2nd overall). This is OSU's 6th appearance in B10 Title game and 1st since '20 (22-10 win over Northwestern) - they are 4-1 in title games. Against 5 common foes, Ohio St is +27.6 ppg/+221 ypg while Indiana is +36.6 ppg/+234 ypg. LY, Indiana came into Horseshoe unbeaten & lost to OSU, 38-15 (+10'). Buckeyes have won 30 straight over Hoosiers dating back to 1992. Last non-loss by Indiana was a 27-27 tie back in 1991. Indiana's last win came in 1987 - 31-10 in Columbus. Buckeyes' RS frosh QB Sayin (78.9%, 30-5) & Hoosiers' QB Mendoza (72.1%, 32-5) are both Heisman candidates. Hoosiers have only lost twice since HC Cignetti took over the program, both LY - to Ohio State & to Notre Dame in the 1st round of the playoffs, 27-17 (+7). LW, Buckeyes snapped 4-gm losing streak to archrival Michigan, 27-9 (-10), while Indiana dominated Purdue, 56-3 (-28') to win Old Oaken Bucket. Cignetti 1st HC since Bo McMillin in 1934-35 to win 1st 2 matchups against rival Purdue. Both teams qualified for postseason regardless of outcome, & both may have locked up 1st round byes. Indiana 7-5 ATS this yr, while OSU 10-2 ATS. Vegas favors Buckeyes -5'. Indiana has the horses to keep it much closer this time.

4★ LA Rams by 14 over ARIZONA – LAR sit at 360.1 YPG and 27.8 PPG and generated solid production LW with QB Matthew Stafford throwing for 243 pass yds and 2 TD, RB Blake Corum adding 81 rush yds and a TD, and WR Xavier Smith providing 82 rec yds, with the two INTs being the only major setback. ARI again posted strong yardage totals but limited scoring efficiency as QB Jacoby Brissett threw for 301 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT and TE Trey McBride added 82 rec yds, while penalties and negative plays continued to halt drives, and WR Marvin Harrison Jr. remains questionable with a heel flare-up. LAR in a good spot here: McVay is 7–1 SU/ATS in Arizona, LAR are 37–9 SU and 28–18 ATS as a road favorite under McVay including 15–1 SU in their last 16, and they are 7–0 ATS after an ATS loss and 6–0 ATS after a SU loss. ARI counters with 1–4 ATS in their last five home games vs winning road teams, giving LAR both the statistical and trend-based edge. Stafford should bounce back big here.

FORECAST: LA Rams by 14

3★ Cincinnati by 3 over BUFFALO – CIN enter with QB Joe Burrow fully reactivating their O LW, posting 261 pass yds and 2 TD while RB Chase Brown added 78 rush yds and WR Ja'Marr Chase delivered 110 rec yds as CIN went over 350 total yards again, a spot they've covered four straight times. BUF leaned heavily on RB James Cook LW (144 rush yds, 177 scrimmage yds) while QB Josh Allen threw for just 123 yds and 1 TD with 1 INT, and the Bills' recent totals profile includes 4 straight Unders after SU wins and five straight Overs after sub-150 passing yds. Trend-wise, Burrow remains elite as a dog: 15–3 ATS as an underdog of more than 3 points and 15–6 ATS vs teams above .500, while CIN/BAL series form held with turnover-driven scoring LW and CIN entering this matchup 2–0 SU/ATS in the last two vs BUF with the Under 5–0 in the L10Y. With Burrow slinging it and BUF's ATS form slipping (1–5 ATS after SU wins), this game should be great for the underdog. **FORECAST: Cincinnati by 3**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ CLEVELAND by 9 over Tennessee – CLE sit at 258.0 YPG and 16.2 PPG and got a steady outing LW from QB Shedeur Sanders with 149 pass yds and a TD while RB Quinshon Judkins added 91 rush yds in a game where stalled drives and a fourth-and-1 fumble prevented a closer finish. TEN remain at the bottom of the league offensively at 242.4 YPG and 14.2 PPG and managed only 141 pass yds from QB Cameron Ward and 60 rush yds from RB Tony Pollard LW while continuing to allow heavy pressure. Trend support is one-sided: CLE is 5–2 ATS at home vs losing road teams, while TEN is 1–8 ATS vs losing teams and 3–14 ATS vs the AFC South since 2023, with multiple Under trends aligning with the 33.5 total. CLE's D holding opponents to 271.2 YPG matches up cleanly against a TEN O that has failed to produce consistent yardage or points. If Sanders wants to be the QB next year this is the defense he needs to go off on, TEN allows the 4th most PPG (27.3) and Myles Garrett looking for the sack record here to a TEN that's allowed 4+ sacks 8 times TY. **FORECAST: CLEVELAND by 9**

OTHER PLAYS

Dallas vs DETROIT – Thursday – DAL enter at 393.1 YPG and 29.2 PPG after a 31–28 win where QB Dak Prescott posted 320 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT, RB Javonte Williams added 59 rush yds and WR CeeDee Lamb had 112 rec yds and a TD, with the defense holding its third straight opponent to 21 offensive points or fewer. DET sit at 376.2 YPG and 29.2 PPG after QB Jared Goff threw for 256 pass yds 2 TD and WR Jameson Williams produced 144 rec yds, while the Lions' short-yardage struggles continued with an 0-for-7 fourth-down skid over the last three weeks. Trend profile shows multiple Over indicators (DAL 8–4 to the Over; DET 12–3 to the Over after ATS losses), though DAL's recent red-zone stops and Detroit's inconsistent conversion rates work in the opposite direction (0–7 4th down L3W). Both offenses have top-tier yardage outputs, but the mixed efficiency and turnovers could tip this one.

MINNESOTA by 4 over Washington – MIN come off a shutout where QB Max Brosmer threw 4 INT with 126 pass yds and the O has produced just 162 total yds across the last six quarters, reflecting a downward spiral heading into JJ McCarthy's return. WAS showed more life LW with QB Marcus Mariota at 294 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT plus 55 rush yds and TE Zach Ertz at 106 rec yds, but they've still dropped to 3–9 and remain 0–6 ATS vs NFC and 0–5 ATS vs losing teams. Historical shutout data favors MIN here as teams off a scoreless game are 33–17–3 ATS since 2015, and MIN's D allow fewer YPG (306.8 vs WAS 388.2) while carrying a 4–0 Under run at home vs losing road teams. Both teams have been sliding, but the matchup and trends line up for this to be a cleaner bounce-back spot for MIN.

Miami by 3 over NY JETS – MIA enter with the more stable O at 300.2 YPG and leaned on RB De'Von Achane's 134 rush yds and a TD LW while QB Tua Tagovailoa added 157 pass yds in a controlled script. NYJ come off a win where QB Tyrod Taylor threw for 172 pass yds and 1 TD, RB Breece Hall added 68 rush yds and a TD and WR Adonai Mitchell posted 102 rec yds, though their O still showed drive-to-drive inconsistency. Trend splits stay mixed with MIA 4–0 ATS after ATS losses but 1–5 ATS after SU wins, while NYJ are 4–1 ATS in their last five yet 2–8–1 ATS after SU wins; totals indicators also conflict with MIA 4–0–1 Under overall vs NYJ 9–1–1 Over vs losing teams. Forecast calls for cold but low-impact weather, minimizing external factors on either offense. With MIA holding the stronger offensive baseline and NYJ less consistent in scoring efficiency, the edge stays with Miami.

Pittsburgh by 1 over BALTIMORE – PIT come off a 26–7 loss where QB Aaron Rodgers threw for 117 pass yds, RB Jaylen Warren added 35 rush yds and 1 TD and TE Darnell Washington posted 45 rec yds, and they also claimed WR Adam Thielen off waivers, a veteran Rodgers has a personal connection with and should trust immediately as a stabilizing target. BAL fell 32–14 with QB Lamar Jackson at 246 pass yds and 1 INT, RB Derrick Henry adding 60 rush yds and a TD and TE Isaiah Likely at 95 rec yds, but Baltimore's 3 turnovers and multiple short-field giveaways defined the loss. Trend profile shows PIT 11–3 ATS after scoring <15 and 6–2 ATS after a double-digit home loss, while BAL are 1–6 ATS after SU losses of more than 14 and 1–5–1 ATS after allowing over 30, with the series on a 9–1 Under run. Weather projects cold with possible precipitation, matching both teams' recent Under splits and historically tight PIT–BAL scoring patterns. With PIT's added veteran WR support and BAL's turnover issues persisting, this matchup stays narrow toward Pittsburgh.

Seattle by 14 over ATLANTA – SEA enter at 352.5 YPG and 29.2 PPG after a 26–0 win where QB Sam Darnold threw for 128 pass yds, RB Kenneth Walker added 56 rush yds and the defense forced 5 takeaways, extending SEA's 7 straight SU wins in the 1:00 PM ET window. ATL posted 234 pass yds and 1 TD from QB Kirk Cousins LW with RB Bijan Robinson at 142 rush yds and TE Kyle Pitts at 82 rec yds, but special-teams errors and coverage breakdowns again played a major role in their loss. Trend profile favors SEA with 5–0 ATS after SU wins, 4–0 ATS vs NFC, and Darnold 10–0 SU / 8–2 ATS as a favorite of 6+ points, while ATL are 1–4–1 ATS in December and sit on strong Under tendencies vs losing teams. SEA also carry the stronger D metrics at 289.4 YPG allowed vs ATL's 318.9 and match well against an ATL defense giving up 23.0 PPG. Seattle holds the statistical and trend support here.

Indianapolis by 3 over JACKSONVILLE – IND enter at 375.4 YPG and 29.8 PPG but have dropped 3 of 4 and come off a game where QB Daniel Jones posted 201 pass yds and 2 TD with RB Jonathan Taylor adding 85 rush yds, though protection issues limited their ceiling. JAX produced 229 pass yds and 2 TD from QB Trevor Lawrence LW with WR Jakobi Meyers at 90 rec yds and a TD, and they've exceeded 350 total yds in 7 of their last 9 games, carrying the historical edge with 6 straight home wins vs IND and 6–2 ATS in the last 8. Trend splits show IND 3–16–1 ATS vs JAX since 2015 and 1–9 ATS in road/neutral meetings, while matchup totals have gone Over 5 straight. IND's advantage comes from their higher-scoring profile and stronger season-long efficiency despite the recent slide, with their O carrying the more explosive metrics Jones just needs to get going here to win.

GREEN BAY by 7 over Chicago – GB enter at 340.6 YPG and 24.5 PPG after a 31–24 win where QB Jordan Love threw for 234 pass yds and 4 TD, RB Josh Jacobs added 83 rush yds and WR Dontayn Wicks posted 94 rec yds and 2 TD. CHI leaned on RB Kyle Monangai's 130 rush yds and a TD LW while QB Caleb Williams added 154 pass yds 1 TD 1 INT, but Chicago remain heavily sack-dependent with an 11–5 SU mark when Williams takes ≤2 sacks and 3–10 SU when he takes 3+. Trend splits show CHI 5–17–1 ATS vs NFC North the last 5 seasons and GB 10–1 SU in December under LaFleur with strong home results on extended prep. Both teams carry Under tendencies in similar setups, but GB's D allowing 18.8 PPG and CHI's red-zone volatility narrow the scoring window. Turnovers will happen and keep this game tighter but Love showed what he could do being let loose, GB should take care of business here.

TAMPA BAY by 7 over New Orleans – TB enter at 316.2 YPG and 23.2 PPG after a 20–17 win where QB Baker Mayfield threw for 194 pass yds and a TD, RB Bucky Irving added 61 rush yds and a TD and WR Chris Godwin looked fully back with 78 rec yds in his most productive outing since returning. NO posted 239 pass yds and 2 TD from QB Tyler Shough LW with RB Devin Neal adding 47 rush yds and WR Devaughn Vele at 93 rec yds and a TD, but their 15.2 PPG offense continues to struggle sustaining drives. Trend splits strongly reflect how these matchups typically play: TB have lost 7 straight ATS at home vs NO, and NO remain 15–6–1 ATS on NFC South roads since 2018, while TB are 1–6 ATS in their last seven home games overall. TB carry the scoring advantage to win the game, but the historical ATS pattern and spread range keep NO inside the 8.5 line.

Denver by 10 over LAS VEGAS – DEN enter at 340.8 YPG and 23.7 PPG after a 27–26 OT win where QB Bo Nix threw for 321 pass yds 1 TD 1 INT, RB RJ Harvey added 35 rush yds and 2 TD and TE Evan Engram posted 79 rec yds, continuing Denver's streak of winning tight games despite trailing in all 12 this season. LV were handled 31–14 LW with QB Geno Smith at 165 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT, RB Ashton Jeanty limited to 31 rush yds and TE Brock Bowers leading with 63 rec yds and both scores, as the offense again struggled behind a line unable to sustain protection or create run lanes. Trends strongly point away from LV with 0–4 SU vs AFC West this year and 0–10 the last two seasons, plus 1–4 ATS in their last five vs the division, while DEN bring multiple Under markers including 6–0 Under vs AFC and 5–1 Under after allowing >250 pass yds. DEN's D allowing 18.2 PPG and LV at just 14.9 PPG on O combine with matchup history (DEN 3–0 SU last three) to keep this in the Broncos' control. Denver carries the stronger scoring and defensive baselines.

Houston vs KANSAS CITY – SNF – HOU enter at 326.8 YPG and 21.9 PPG after a 20–16 win where QB C.J. Stroud posted 276 pass yds 1 INT, RB Jo'quavious Marks added 64 rush yds and WR Nico Collins contributed 98 rec yds plus a rushing TD, with HOU now 3–9 to the total this season. KC come in at 374.8 YPG and 25.4 PPG off a 31–28 loss where QB Patrick Mahomes threw for 261 pass yds and 4 TD, RB Kareem Hunt added 58 rush yds and WR Rashee Rice had 92 rec yds and 2 TD, while KC remain 4–8 to the total. Trend numbers show KC on a 6–1 Under run overall and HOU 4–0 Under after SU wins, but the posted total of 41.5 narrows that edge and KC have produced several higher-scoring home night games behind Mahomes. Weather projects cold with no reported precipitation, keeping conditions stable for both offenses. With mixed ATS splits and totals trends defined by opposite patterns vs game flow, this matchup will effectively keep playoff hopes alive or crush them.

Philadelphia vs LA CHARGERS – MNF – PHI enter at 304.8 YPG and 22.5 PPG after a 24–15 loss where QB Jalen Hurts threw for 230 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT, RB Saquon Barkley added 56 rush yds and WRA.J. Brown posted 132 rec yds and 2 TD, and Hurts now sits 1–4 ATS in his last 5 MNF starts. LAC come in at 346.8 YPG and 23.1 PPG after a 31–14 win where QB Justin Herbert totaled 151 pass yds 2 TD 1 INT, RB Kimani Vidal ran for 126 rush yds 1 TD and WR Ladd McConkey added 39 rec yds 1 TD, and the Chargers remain 5–0 to the Over after scoring 30+ and 4–0 to the Over in B2B home games. Trend splits show PHI 7–1 ATS vs winning teams and 5–1 ATS on the road vs winning home teams, while LAC are 4–1 SU/ATS in B2B home games but 1–4 ATS after SU wins; totals indicators remain split as MNF leans the other way (PHI 6–1 Under last 7 Mon; LAC 7–1 Under last 8 Mon). Hurts vs Herbert will be interesting.
