Army lost 14 straight in this rivalry from '02-'15 but they've now won 6 of the last 8 meetings (5-3 ATS). The Under is 17-1 in this series with the only Over coming two years ago thanks to 2 OT's.

Navy had 14 starters back this year after going 5-7 last year. The Midshipmen had a soft early schedule and started 6-0 and all of those wins were by double-digits including a 12 point win over Memphis. Navy had 6 Turnovers against Notre Dame and QB Horvath was injured. They lost 51-14 then caught Rice on the Interim HC bounce and were upset 24-10. Navy beat USF 35-0 which set up our 5H GOY and Tulane won easily 35-0 (-7). Navy beat East Carolina 34-20 in their last game. They enter 8-3 but -6 ypg and -25 ypg vs AAC foes. QB Horvath missed the last game but Braxton Woodson threw for 165 and ran for 125. Navy rushes for 248 (5.4). Their defense is led by LB Colin Ramos who has 110 tackles and was 1st Team All-AAC.

Army finished 6-6 last season but two wins were over FCS teams so they didn't get invited to a bowl for the 2nd straight season. The Black Knights only had 11 starters back this year. They opened 9-0 against a very soft schedule (only 2 teams that reached bowls) but all of those wins did come by double-digits. Army played Notre Dame in Yankee Stadium and was no match in a 49-14 loss. They rebounded with their two best wins of the season, beating UTSA 29-24 then upset Tulane in the AAC Title game 35-14. QB Bryson Daily was 1st Tm AAC (1480 rush, 877 pass, 37 td's). They also had two OL make 1st Tm AAC.

Army has won the Commander-In-Chief trophy in five of the last 7 seasons. They have the edge on both offense and defense, plus a big ST's edge (#2 vs #116) but the underdog is 22-6 ATS in Military Academy games. Our checklist has Army by 7 which is right at the line but we would rather ride the trend and take the Under which has hit in 17 of the last 18 games between Army and Navy!

The Celebration Bowl is played at Mercedes Benz Stadium in Atlanta, GA between the winners of the MEAC and SWAC in the FCS. The MEAC winner is 6-2 SU in Celebration Bowls. These two have met in this game back in '21 when SCSt won 31-10. This is Jackson St's 3rd trip to the Celebration Bowl and they lost both including in '22 when Deion Sanders coached his last game here and they lost 41-34 in OT to NC Central.

TC Taylor was OC for 2 years under Deion Sanders and took over when Coach Prime left for Colorado. JSU went 7-4 in Taylor's first year but failed to win the SWAC. This year they added Syracuse transfer QB Jacobian Morgan. JSU opened 2-2 with road losses to ULM and Grambling then won their last 8 regular season games to reach the SWAC Title game. They had a rematch with Southern last week and won 41-13. Morgan has thrown for 2,003 (63%) with a 19-7 ratio. RB Irv Mulligan has 1,174 (6.5) and 11 td's. JSU is +124 ypg. Their defense allows just 281 ypg and holds foes 40 ypg below their average. Only 2 of their 11 wins are by single-digits.

SCSt went 5-6 in '23. They brought in grad transfer QB Eric Phoenix from Murray St. The Gamecocks opened with 3 road games including at Georgia Southern and started 1-2. They won their next 8 games, including all 5 MEAC games. Six of those wins came by 20 points or more. SCSt finished 9-2 and are +138 ypg. The Gamecocks avg 426 ypg and Phoenix finished with a 20-7 ratio but he missed their season finale vs Norfolk St. SCSt did win 53-21 with a 510-261 yd edge in that game and backup QB Ryan Stubblefield has a 5-1 ratio. SCSt's D is holding foes 35 ypg below their avg and their offense avg 85 ypg more than their foes allow.

The MEAC has a built in advantage with 3 weeks off prior to this game but JSU appears to be the better team. SC has a small edge on offense but their QB is ? so we are making this a no play.

FORECAST: NO PLAY RATING: NO PLAY

First meeting. SALa is in a bowl for the 3rd straight ssn. LY SALa won their first bowl, beating MAC foe EMich 59-10 (+477 yds).SALa HC Applewhite is coaching in his 1st bowl here and overall is 0-3 SU/ATS in bowls. This is WMich's first bowl for HC Taylor and their first bowl since '21 when they beat Nev 52-24 in the Quick Lane Bowl.

SALa entered '24 with just 7 starters back and a 1st year HC. They opened the season 0-2 then won 2 straight incl a 48-14 win at App St. After 2 losses dropped them to 2-4, SALa would go on to win 4 of their final 6 games to finish the season 6-6 and reach a bowl in a season they were expected to be down. The Jags were led by rFr QB Lopez, who started 11 games and threw for 2,557 yds (66%), 18-5 and also ran for 465 (5.7). SALa has a solid 1-2 punch at RB with Bothwell (834, 7.4) and Bullock (702, 5.2) plus WR Pritchett topped 1000 yards (1126, 12.4). SALa was +62 in SBC play, but their defense did allow teams to gain 8 ypg above their avg (#82) but SALa was +8 TO's and they have the #77 pass D.

WMich was the most exp'd team in the MAC entering '24 with 17 starters back and were in year 2 under HC Taylor. WMich dropped 3 of 4 games in non-conf play but 2 of those were vs Ohio St and Wisconsin and they only trailed Wisky 13-7 into the 4Q. WMich won their F/4 MAC games but those were against Ball St, Akron, Buffalo and Kent. They lost their next 3 against tougher MAC competition and needed a 26-18 win in the finale to get win #6. WMich QB Wolff had a solid ratio (67%, 17-7) and they had 3 RB's top 500 rush yards. WMich did struggle on defense, allowing foes to gain 71 ypg above their avg (#122) and their pass D ranks #114.

SALa RB Bothwell did enter the portal, but they still have a good RB and WM's run D allowed 213 (5.5) the L/4 gms. WMich has a poor defense, but can move the ball & SALa allowed 530 yds & 45 pts in their last game. The total is resonable and we like the Over.

FORECAST: OVER 57 RATING: 3★

First meeting. This is 9 bowls in 11 years for WVU, but they will be under interim HC Chad Scott after Neal Brown was fired after a disappointing 6-6 season. WVU is just 1-7 ATS in their L/8 bowls. Memphis has made a bowl in every season Ryan Silverfield has been HC and he is 3-0 SU/ATS (bowl in '21 was cancelled and bowl in '19 was as interim HC).

Memphis entered '24 with an exp'd team (17 st's) led by QB Seth Henigan and their top 2 WR's plus 7 starters on defense. Memphis opened 3-0 and beat Florida St on the road then lost at Navy the next week. After that Memphis won 4 straight before losing 44-36 at UTSA. Memphis closed out the season with 3 straight wins to finish with 10 wins including an upset at Tulane to close out the season. QB Henigan threw for 3,208 yards (64%, 23-6) and overall the offense put up 442 ypg/35 ppg. The defense did hold foes to 15 ypg under their season avg (#65). The pass D did struggle a bit, allowing 300+ yards in 4 of their last 6 games but they ranked #50 (59%, 15-10) and they allowed only 104 rush (3.8).

WVU entered '24 with 13 starters and high expectations after a 9-4 season in '23. WVU lost to Penn St then after an FCS win lost to Pitt after winning for much of the game. WVU started B12 play 2-0 but then dropped B2B gms vs ISU and Kan St. They closed the season winning 3 of their last 5 but lost the finale 52-15 and Brown was fired. WVU has a strong run game led by White and Donaldson at RB plus QB Greene. The defense struggled down the stretch, allowing 466 ypg/37 ppg in the L/4 games and their pass D allowed 269 ypg and they finished the season ranked #121 (63%, 24-5).

Memphis has the edge at coach and they have a strong pass attack taking on a weak passing defense. We think Memphis has a clear edge here and will back them in this matchup as the line is around a fg and the checklist has them by over a td!

Indy has not allowed a sack in their L/2 games but DEN's pass rush has 16 sks in the L/4 games and DEN has forced 18 TO's this season while Indy has 20 TO's this ssn. Indy (119 rush, 4.4) faces a DEN run D allowing just 95 ypg (3.8). On offense DEN QB Nix is hitting 64% with a 17-8 ratio and here faces a Indy pass D allowing 70% and 232 ypg on the season. 2★ DETROIT over Buffalo - Two of the NFL's best teams meet up here. DET has the rest edge having played last Thur while BUF played Sun in LA and now are back on the road. BUF's pass D has allowed 72% the L/4 games and last week allowed 320 pass yds at LAR. DET QB Goff is hitting 72% with a 25-10 ratio and DET has 5 players with 300+ rec yds incl both RB's. Despite DET's defense taking inj's, they have only allowed 257 ypg over the L/5 games incl allowing just 74 rush ypg (3.5). While QB Allen is hitting 64% (23-5 ratio) and he threw for 342 yds last week, DET's pass is allowing just 52% the L/4 gms and they are 4th in the NFL with 14 int's. DET is 8-1SU/7-2 ATS against the AFC since '23 & are 10-3 ATS as home chalk vs non-div foes since '22. With the line under a fg we feel like DET is the stronger team & they have the home crowd edge. **FORECAST: Detroit by 10**

OTHER PLAYS

La Rams vs SAN FRANCISCO - Thursday - Since 2019 SF is 9-3 SU/8-3-1 ATS against the Rams, but the Rams did pull the outright upset earlier this season 27-24. After starting the season 1-4, the Rams have won 6 of the L/8 games (5-3 ATS) and handed Buffalo just their 3rd loss of the season last week, as they put up 457 yds incl 320 passing in a 44-42 win. SF snapped a 3 game losing streak last week with a 38-13 win over CHI as QB Purdy threw for 321 yds and the DEF allowed just 162 yds and recorded 7 sacks. While SF has only allowed 149 pass ypg over the past 4 games, they are allowing 72% completions and the Rams pass attack is avg'g 245 ypg (68%) over the L/4 games. Despite all their inj's SF's defense is still allowing just 299 ypg & holding foes to 42 ypg under their avg. **Call the office on Thur after Noon EST for the Marquee Winner!**

Washington by 13 over NEW ORLEANS - WAS enters here 8-5 and looking to stay in the hunt for a wildcard spot while the Saints have actually won 3 of their L/4 but are just 5-8. The Saints defense allows foes to gain 52 ypg above their season average (#30 NFL) and Wash is off a bye and their rush attack with RB Robinson and QB Daniels avg's 157 ypg (4.9) and in their last game they ran for 267 (5.9) vs a good TEN defense. NOLA will likely be without QB Carr for this game due to inj and in the 3 games Carr missed earlier this season the Saints lost those games by 18, 23 and 24 points. The Saints are also missing several weapons on offense and WAS is holding foes to 6 ypg under their avg (#13) and have all'd just 331 ypg the L/4 games. Off a bye we like WAS to cruise.

Miami by 4 over HOUSTON - HOU is back at home after a bye week and have gone just 3-4 since starting the season 5-1. Miami has played their way back into the playoff hunt, winning 4 of their L/5 games. While HOU has allowed just 59% completions the L/4 games, they have given up 269 pass ypg and the Dolphins pass attack is putting up 312 ypg (75%) the L/4 weeks. Miami's run defense is only allowing 84 ypg (4.0) the L/7 games and HOU is only avg'g 114 (4.2) rushing. Miami's pass D is allowing 67% and 261 ypg the L/4 games but HOU QB Stroud is having a down season. Also Miami has 14 sacks the L/5 games HOU's OL has allowed 42 sacks on the season and their offense is avg'g just 306 ypg over the past 4 games. HOU is just 1-3-1 ATS as a HF this season and we like the Dolphins to get the outright win as this game does not take place in cold weather.

Ny Jets by 1 over JACKSONVILLE - Both teams enter this game with a 3-10 record. The Jets put up a fight last week in MIA but now are back on the road in Florida and have now lost 4 straight games. NYJ has only avg'd 300 ypg on the season and the L/4 games are only putting up 280 ypg. The Jets are dealing with several inj's to their OL and RB Hall has been banged up. Jets only average 87 rush ypg (4.1). JAX won at TEN last week 10-6 despite only putting up 291 yds but backup QB Jones threw for 220 yards and the Jets did allow 331 pass last week. While the Jags are struggling it is impossible to trust the Jets to cover (1-8-1 ATS the L/10 gms).

Cincinnati by 7 over TENNESSEE - Cincy is back on the road on short rest after their 27-20 win Dallas on Monday, while the Titans are just 3-10 SU (2-10-1 ATS) and lost at home to JAX. TEN's offense only puts up 295 ypg/17 ppg and their OL line has given up 45 sacks on the season. On the other hand Cincy's offense is humming of late, putting up 433 ypg/32 ppg over the L/4 games and QB Burrow is #1 in the NFL in pass yards and TD passes while WR Chase is #1 in rec yds and TD's. TEN does hold foes to 44 ypg under their season avg (#2) but they have allowed 70% completions the L/4 games and Cincy is avg'g 65% with 351 pass ypg the L/4 gms. Cincy's D struggles (417 ypg all'd the L/4 gms) but they are taking on a weak offense and the Bengals offense will do enough here to get the win by a td.

Baltimore by 14 over NY GIANTS - The Ravens are off a bye and have lost 2 of their L/3 games but that was to PIT and Philly. The Giants are only allowing 142 rush ypg (4.9) but do face a potent Ravens rush attack and QB Jackson is hitting 67% with a 25-3 ratio and the Giants allow 69% completions. NYG did have 35 sacks in their F/8 games but only have 3 sacks in their last 5 games. While the Giants are awful (1-7 SU/ATS the L/8 gms) the Ravens have 2 much bigger games on deck vs PIT and at HOU and this line is over 2 td's. BAL is just 2-10 ATS since '22 as a favorite of over 7 pts including going 0-2 as a DD favorite, so we'll call for this game to finish right at 2 td's.

Kansas City by 3 over CLEVELAND - KC enters this matchup 12-1 and already have clinched the AFC West with a last-second win against LAC last week. KC has 10 wins by 7 points or less this season and their last 4 wins are by 3 pts or less. CLE's season has been a downward spiral and they are just 3-10 SU (4-9 ATS) and while the offense has been feisty at times with QB Winston, they still only avg 313 ypg and the run game is putting up just 89 ypg (3.8). Plus the CLE OL line has been banged up and have allowed 53 sacks. KC holds teams to 35 ypg under their season avg (#4 NFL) and allow just 88 rush ypg (4.0). Their secondary has been ? at times, allowing 66% and 256 pass ypg the L/4 games. CLE might be able to exploit that secondary and Winston has hit some deep shots. KC doesn't cover these games (0-7 ATS slide) and that will again happen here.

CAROLINA by 4 over Dallas - Despite sitting at just 3 wins on the season and riding a current 3 game losing streak, CAR has shown signs of life in those 3 losses, as they have lost to Philly, TB and KC all by 6 pts or less. CAR QB Young has shown signs of improvement since his benching as he has avg'd 210 pass ypg over the last 4 starts. DAL is off a MON night loss to Cincy where they allowed 433 yards incl 359 pass yds in a 27-20 loss. DAL still has a solid pass rush (36 sks) but CAR has allowed just 10 sks the L/8 weeks. PIT is 7-1 SU/ATS in their L/8 games while Philly has now won 9 in a row (6-3 ATS). Philly the last 2 games have only put up 252 and 292 yards and the Steelers defense holds foes to 24 ypg under their season avg (#6 NFL). Philly's offense is led by RB Barkley is #1 in the NFL (1623, 6.1, 11 td) but the Steelers only allow 92 rush ypg (4.1). PIT has also forced a league-best 28 TO's. Philly's defense is also talented, allowing just 248 ypg during their win streak and PIT is putting up 367 ypg since QB Wilson took over. PIT is 5-0 SU/ATS as an underdog this season and are getting over a fg. We like the Steelers to cover here and possibly pull the outright upset.

ARIZONA by 7 over New England - After winning 4 straight games to grab a lead in the NFC West, Ariz has dropped 3 straight games and are now under .500 at 6-7. NE comes in with just 3 wins and have dropped 3 in a row, but are off a bye week. NE's offense has been able to move the ball better (350 ypg L/4 gms) and their defense is allowing just 293 ypg the L/4 gms. Their pass D did allow 308 to MIA in their last road game and Ariz is avg'g 249 pass ypg (71%) over the L/4 gms and have TE McBride and WR Harrison as major weapons. We like the Cardinals to get back in the win column, but we will only lean slightly with them as this Patriots team is off a bye and can be scrappy.

Green Bay vs SEATTLE - SNF - Big matchup in Seattle on Sun night. SEA has won 4 straight since losing 5 of 6 games earlier this season and are now on top in the NFC West. GB is off extra rest as they played last Thur in DET and nearly came away with the win despite only putting up 298 yds. GB's pass D does struggle at times, and they are allowing 256 ypg (74%) over the L/4 games, while SEA QB Smith is #2 in the NFL in passing (3474, 70%) and WR Smith-Njigba is having a stellar sophomore ssn and is #6 in the league in rec yds. Smith does have 12 int's this season (19 total TO's by SEA) and GB has 24 takeaways this season (tied 3rd NFL). SEA allows 65% completions and GB QB Love avg's 247 pass ypg and is hitting 63% with a talented group of receivers & a strong run gm. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for the Marquee Winner!**

Chicago vs MINNESOTA - MNF - CHI did not get the typical head coach bump last week, as they lost by 25 pts and were -290 yds at SF. Minn picked up their 6th straight win last week at home vs ATL, as they were outgained 496-433 but were +3 TO's and won 42-21. These teams met less than a month ago, and CHI came back from 10 pts down in the 4Q to force OT, but lost 30-27. The Bears have now dropped 7 in a row and have only topped 20 pts 1 time during that losing streak.
