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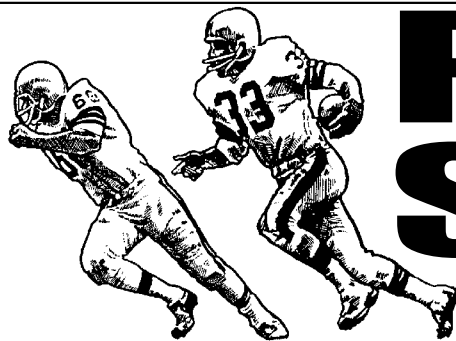

These two last met back in 1964 and 1966 when they split two meetings. Indiana is playing for their first CFB National Title. Curt Cignetti coached in the FCS National Title game in 2019 at James Madison but lost to North Dakota St. Miami has won 5 National Titles but the last was back in '01 when they crushed Nebraska.

Miami beat Notre Dame in the opener but losses to Louisville and SMU kept them from the ACC Title game. The win over ND was enough for an at-large bid. Miami's D held Texas A&M to 3 points and Ohio St to 10 points in their first 2 playoff games. Carson Beck looked like the projected #1 draft pick vs Ole Miss in the Semifinals, throwing for 268 and 2 td's in a 31-27 win. The 'Canes D is allowing just 293 ypg and they have 47 sacks led by DE's Bain and Mesidor. The D holds foes 117 ypg below their avg.

Indiana has passed all tests heading into this game. They went 12-0 in the regular season with only 3 close wins. The Hoosiers knocked off Ohio St for their first Big 10 Title then crushed Alabama 38-3 in the quarterfinals. Last week's rematch with Oregon was a 56-22 route thanks to +3 TO's. We give Indiana a big edge on offense. QB Mendoza has more td passes (8) than incompletions (5) in their 2 playoff games and Indiana has 2 of CFB's best WR's in Cooper and Sarraff. Their D allows just 11 ppg/261 ypg and holds foes 107 ypg below their avg (#7 in FBS).

Miami has a home field edge playing this game at Hard Rock Stadium in Miami. Don't be shocked if Indiana has just as many fans though as Indiana has the largest living alumni base in the country and they packed Mercedes Benz Stadium last week! Miami has 47 sacks but Mendoza gets the ball out quickly. Carson Beck threw 6 int's in their 2 losses TY which could spell trouble against Indiana's ball-hawking secondary. There's no value with Indiana laying over a td but we still call for the Hoosiers to win by 2 scores.

SEA just saw SF in Week 18 and handled them 13-3, and now they get the same opponent again with a massive rest edge. SF is on 6 days rest while SEA is on 14, and teams with that type of rest advantage (14 vs 6) are 7-0 SU in the cited sample since 1984. SF also fits the Divisional Round profile that has struggled badly: teams that won as underdogs in the Wild Card round are 8-30 SU since 2003. Add in the scheduling spot with SF on short rest again, and it's a tough setup walking into Lumen.

SF's season numbers are strong (13-5 SU/11-7 ATS), and they can still hang around with the run game and backs. They ran for 1,817 yds (3.8) led by RB McCaffrey (1,202 rush, 102-924-7 rec), but they're taking a major hit in this round with TE Kittle out for the season (Achilles) and WR Pearsall questionable (knee/PCL). At QB they've had to split time with Purdy (20-10) and Jones (13-6), and that's a problem when you're missing a primary middle-of-field target like Kittle. Trend-wise, SF has also been a January fade recently (1-6 ATS L7 Jan gms), and +7.5 is one of the biggest dog numbers in franchise playoff history.

SEA has been the more reliable profile all year (14-3 SU/12-5 ATS) and their offense is built to stretch you. QB Darnold threw for 4,048 yds (25-14) and he's been automatic in this favorite range: as a fav of 6+ he's 13-0 SU and 10-3 ATS, winning those games by 16.1 ppg. The run game is a true two-back setup with Walker (1,027) and Charbonnet (730), and the pass game has a matchup nightmare in JSN (119-1,793-10) with Kupp (593) and Barner (519, 67 TD) providing secondary production. Defensively, SEA has takeaways and pressure with Ernest Jones posting 5 INT and the DL duo of Leonard Williams and Byron Murphy combining for 14 sks.

Totals trends point two different ways with Under 5-0 in SF's last 5 Divisional playoff games and Under 9-1 in SF's last 10 playoff road games, while Over 4-0 in SEA's last 4 Divisional playoff games. We're not overcomplicating it: SEA is the rested home team coming off a Week 18 win vs this opponent, they've got the better QB continuity and healthier weapons, and Lumen Field has been a real edge with SEA winning 10 straight home playoff games outright with fans. Not to mention Darnold 13-0 SU (10-3 ATS) when Fav of 6+, winning those games by 16.1 PPG. We'll lay it with Seattle to take control and advance.
