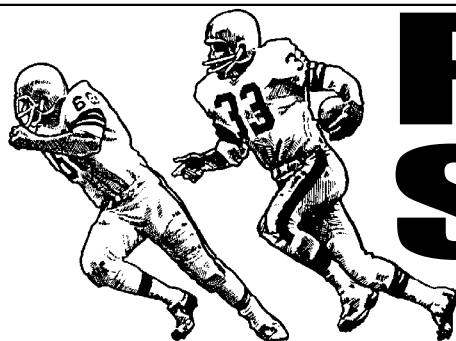

Bo Nix being OUT is the headline and it flips the entire setup. DEN just beat BUF 33-30 in OT with Nix throwing for 279 yds (3 TD, 1 INT), and now they go from a QB-driven offense to Jarrett Stidham expected to start in the AFC title game. That's on top of DEN coming off the OT hangover spot where teams off a playoff OT win in the next round since 2015 are 0-5 SU and 1-4 ATS, and they're also dealing with skill questions with WR Franklin questionable (hamstring) and WR Bryant doubtful (concussion). DEN does get the rest edge (played Sat while NE played Sun), but the QB switch is still the biggest variable in the game.

NE is rolling and they've been automatic away from home. They're 8-0 SU and 7-1 ATS on the road this season, and Maye has been dominant as a fav of 3+ at 12-0 SU and 10-2 ATS. They also keep stacking wins off a win (13-2 SU and 11-4 ATS), and the overall cover profile gap is wide with NE 14-5 ATS vs DEN 8-10 ATS. Even last week, in a disgusting sloppy weather game, Maye stayed efficient and got them through with 179 pass yds (3 TD, 1 INT) in the 28-16 win over HOU.

DEN's D and home altitude still matter, and DEN has been strong historically in CC games (8-2 SU, 9-1 ATS Super Bowl era; at home CC 6-1 SU/ATS), plus Payton has been competitive as a HD (career 12-10 SU and 13-9 ATS). Market-wise, DEN +5.5 is the largest HD in a CC game since the merger era, and if it closes +4 or more the long-run playoff trend is loud with HD of 4+ sitting 9-0 ATS over the last 50 years. Ref-wise, DEN has also been strong with Alex Kemp (6-1 ATS and 4-0 SU at home).

The play is the Over here. In CC/SB since 2003, totals 41 or less have leaned Over at 8-2-2. (it may push down there) and both teams bring current Over streaks into this one with Over 6-1 in NE's last 7 games overall and Over 5-1 in DEN's last 6 games following a SU win. Even with the QB change, DEN can still generate points with short fields and red zone chances, and QB Stidham will be asked to push it when the matchup gives him throws. With NE's offense steady and DEN's environment creating volatility, points should show up one way or another.
