4★ ALABAMA over Wisconsin - Last year, Bama beat Wisc in Madison, 42-10 (Badgers' most lopsided home loss since '08), behind 5 Jalen Milroe TDs as 14'-pt fav. Wisconsin led 3-0 but lost their starting QB Van Dyke. UW trailed 14-3 and missed a 44-yd FG with :33 left and Bama went 73 in 2 plays for TD to lead 21-3 at half. Bama went 18 yds in 3 (after fum) and 37 yds in just 1 play (after PR) for back-to-back TD's to win by 32 with only a 407-290 yard edge. This is the Badgers 1st trip to Bama. Badgers are 0-5 ATS last 5 as road dog vs ranked opp and Tide is 23-9-1 ATS as a HF the last 6 years. Bama was a 2-TD favorite at Florida St in the opener and were stunned, 31-17. Last week Alabama demolished ULM, 73-0 (-34'), with QB Ty Simpson completing a school-record 17 straight passes. Wisc got a 17-0 shutout in the opener vs Miami (OH), despite losing QB Edwards to a knee sprain in the 1st Q. Last week, with Danny O'Neil (San Diego St. transfer) making his starting debut, Wisc only led Middle Tenn 14-10 at half and yds were nearly even then the Badgers tacked on four 2H td's. Bama has Georgia on the road on deck but DeBoer will want to keep momentum going after losing their opener so we the Tide rolls to a lopsided win by over 4 td's!

FORECAST: ALABAMA by 31

3★ NORTH TEXAS over Washington St -First meeting. North Texas is just 1-6 SU (lost 6 str) all time vs P12 teams but 4-6 ATS. Washington St is 7-3 SU & 8-2 ATS in road openers but this year are under a new HC with just 21 returning lettermen (8 ret Starters). This is a very experienced NT team with 14 returning starters North Texas (-25.5) opened the season with a 51-0 over Lamar. QB Drew Mestemaker threw for 393 yds in the bowl LY (his first start), threw for 329 in the opener. LW in his first road start he struggled some with just 224 as NT (-10) needed OT to get past Western Michigan 33-30. The Cougars are led by rFr Jaxon Potter who in his first 2 starts has combined for 465 yds hitting 70.8% with a 4-0 ratio. He has also only been sacked once in his 74 pass attempts. However both those were both in a friendly home stadium and now this young QB (and young team in general) will be making his first road start in a long trip south to Denton, Texas. They also have the Apple Cup on deck. With that in mind a home favorite of less than a TD is a strong play here!

FORECAST: NORTH TEXAS by 16

3★ Vanderbilt over SOUTH CAROLINA -Vandy has been the underdog darlings since last year, pulling five outright upsets and were 8-2 ATS as the underdogs but they did lose to South Carolina 28-7 (+6). These teams already have a common foe, with both teams having played Virginia Tech. Vandy trailed 20-10 at half then scored 34 straight and won 44-24 (+2). SC opened with VTech and won 24-11 (-7), getting a PR td and a late 64 yard td pass. Vandy has lost 16 straight in this series and SC has covered 9 of the last 10 meetings but the home team is 1-4 ATS and we can't go against QB Pavia who has a 25-5 ratio since last year and has led wins over Bama, KY and Auburn along with close losses to Mizzou, Texas and LSU. We made the mistake of going against Vandy as a dog last week. We aren't making the same mistake twice as they are getting over a fg against an overrated South Carolina team.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Utah over WYOMING -Renewal of historic rivalry last played in 2010. Utah is out of the gates fast with lopsided wins over UCLA & Cal Poly by a combined score of 106-19. With Devon Dampier at QB (371 tot yds/4 td's vs Wyoming LY as NMem QB), Kyle Whittingham now has a potent offense to go along with his always solid D and STs. The altitude edge Wyoming enjoys in Laramie won't be a factor against Utah. The Cowboys are 2-0 SU & ATS after beating Akron (+5'), 10-0, and Northern Iowa (+14'), 31-7. However, QB Kaden Anderson left the UNI game with an upper body injury and his return this wk is uncertain. Landon Sims came off the bench to complete 3-3 passes and rush for 8 yds. An already weak Wyoming offense can't afford to be without Anderson. Even with Texas Tech in the on-deck circle, Utah is playing at such a high level and we think they are starting an ATS streak that we are on the right side of!

FORECAST: Utah by 31

2★ Georgia over TENNESSEE -This has been a one-sided rivalry recently. The Dawgs have won the last 8 in the series (7-1 ATS) by 25 ppg and UGA's last 4 wins in Knoxville have come by 31 ppg. Vols have been the more impressive team so far, but those wins came over Syracuse (who barely escaped at home vs UConn LW) and FCS ETSU. QB Joey Aguilar has a 5-0 ratio but takes a huge step up in competition vs UGA's defense. Georgia has been underwhelming in wins over Marshall and Austin Peay but HC Smart is notorious for sandbagging games when they are huge favorites (now 0-10 ATS vs FCS). Tenn will be w/o veteran starting CB's Jermod McCoy and Ricky Gibson. Heupel's offense has been held 170 ypg below their avg in 4 mtgs vs UGA. During UGA's 8 game winning streak they've outgained the Vols by an avg of 175 ypg. Kirby Smart is 20-14 as an AF while the Vols are just 6-13 ATS as a home dog since '16. With the line only UGA -3' this seems like a cheap line in a series dominated by the Bulldogs.

NC State at WAKE FOREST - The home team dominated this series from '97-'22, going 22-4 SU/21-5 ATS but the visitor is 2-0 SU/ATS in the last 2. Last year WF was +3', the 'Pack had a 271-142 yd edge at half but trailed 17-16. CJ Bailey threw for 272 yards and NCST led 30-20 4Q but RB Claiborne had two td's in the last 9 minutes and WF won 34-30. NCST allowed 514 yards last week and they trailed 21-7 3Q. RB Smothers ran for 140 and the Pack rallied to win 35-31 (-3). WF is also 2-0 but NCST has played the tougher early schedule and WF barely got by Kennesaw St in wk1 and LW they beat a Western Carolina team that is missing their preseason AA QB. Series history says take the home team but NCST looks like the better team on paper. Call 1-800-654-3448 or goto ncsports.com and purchase our Thursday Night Marquee for just \$15.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 12th

HOUSTON by 10 over Colorado - First regular season meeting and kickoff to the Big 12 schedule for both. Buffs began this yr at a big experience disadvantage vs Houston (#72 vs #33 on my Exp Chart). This is also their first road gm after splitting home gms with GT and Delaware. Colorado wasn't sharp in either game. The 27-20 loss to GT was more lopsided than the score indicated, and they were just +2 yds vs a Blue Hens (-24) team playing with a backup QB. Buffs won, 31-7, but needed a spark from 3rd string QB Ryan Staub. Whoever gets the ball Friday will face a nasty Houston D. Cougars are 2-0 SU & ATS, allowing 9 total pts to Stephen F Austin and Rice. In the 35-9 win over the rival Owls (+12'), Houston gave up just 51 pass yds. This is a step up in competition, but the Cougar D is well ahead of a Colorado offense still adjusting to life after Shedeur Sanders & Travis Hunter. We like Houston by more than a td in another low-scoring gm.

Kansas St by 2 over ARIZONA - This is a non-conf gm since it was scheduled before Arizona joined Big 12. Kansas St (-7) won LY's mtg at home, 31-7, outrushing Arizona 235-56. KSU has been one of the big disappointments so far this ssn. The preseason contender lost to Iowa St in a gm it could have won, had to rally to beat ND Dakota (+27') and was just upset at home by Army (+17'), which was using a backup QB and lost to Tarleton St Wk 1. This is still a talented tm but after gaining just 246yds vs Army they have to turn things around now before the ssn starts slipping away. Arizona is 2-0 SU & ATS, beating Hawaii & Weber St by 88-9 combined. QB Noah Fifita is playing

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with more confidence, WR Javin Whitley (Chattanooga) has been a find and the D is creating TO's. However, this is a step up in weight class. Plus, KSU is better coached and desperate. With its back against the wall, we have KSU getting out of Tucson with a hard-fought win.

UCLA by 15 over New Mexico - First regular season meeting (Lobos lost to UCLA in '02 Vegas Bowl, 27-13). The Lobos are 4-13 SU all-time vs current & former P12 teams (3 straight ATS wins including last year vs Washington). UCLA is 16-30 ATS since 2014 (lost last year vs Fresno). As DD favorite since '14, UCLA is 16-20 ATS. UCLA was destroyed by Utah, 43-10, in the opener at home. Last week, UCLA was upset by UNLV, 30-23 (-2) - UNLV's 1st B10 win in 22 years! Tenn. transfer Nico lamaleava is hitting 63% with a 2-2 ratio and added 106 yards rushing. New Mexico is 4-0 ATS in non-conf road games the last 2 years and covered at Michigan, only trailing 27-17 in the 4th Quarter. Last week, New Mexico defeated FCS Idaho St, 32-22 (-18'). The Bruins are the early Vegas favorite (-15'). This is a must-win for UCLA after starting 0-2, and we think it is due for that long awaited 1st win this week.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 13th

Memphis by 10 over TROY - Teams meet for second straight year. Memphis (-19) won LY at home, 38-17. They broke open a 7-7 gm with 24 unanswered pts and held the Trojans to 251 yds (2nd lowest total of '24). Memphis is 2-0 SU & ATS this season, beating Chattanooga (+30'), 45-10, and Georgia St (+15), 38-16. The Tigers were up by just 1 at HT and allowed 340 passing yds, but shut out the Panthers 21-0 in the 2H for the win and cover. Troy almost delivered the shocker of Week 2. They were a 31pt dog at Clemson but took a 16-0 lead and only allowed 316 yds before fading in a 27-16 loss. It was an impressive effort, especially after the Trojans needed a 4Q rally to beat Nicholls a week earlier. Memphis' defensive pressure will force Troy into costly mistakes, and the ground gm of RB Sutton Smith and QB Brendon Lewis will control the clock. We expect Troy to play more like they did in Week 1 than Week 2 and lose at home by double-digits.

Oklahoma by 21 over TEMPLE - Oklahoma is making their first trip to Philly since 1942. Last year OK won 51-3 (-42') but only put up 378 yards in that game. Sooners are in a massive Michigan/Auburn sandwich and they only won their opener 35-3 (-37') against FCS Illinois St. Temple is 2-0 SU/ATS under new HC K Keeler. The Owls are off a 55-7 win over Howard and also beat UMass 42-10 (-2) in their opener. John Mateer led Oklahoma in both passing (270, 1 td) and rushing (74, 3.9) last week in their 24-13 (-5). The Sooners D held Michigan to 288 yards and 12 FD's. They have a huge talent edge over Temple but the situation clearly favors the home underdog. Venables is 3-7-1 as a road favorite while Keeler was 3-1 as a home dog at Sam Houston.

Oregon by 31 over NORTHWESTERN - These two teams have met once before - NW won, 14-10, in Evanston in '74. This is their first official mtg as B10 rivals. Ducks made 4 trips to different time zones last year & went 3-1 ATS. As road favorite since '18, Oregon is 17-9 ATS. Over the last 3 years, Oregon is 12-7 ATS as DD conf fav. Since '16, Cats are 11-15-1 ATS as home dog (1-3 LY). Oregon blew out a Montana St team that was 12-0 last year in the opener, 59-13, and last week Oregon destroyed OKSt, 69-3 (-28'). QB Dante Moore looks like the QB he was projected to be, hitting 78% with a 6-0 ratio through 2 gms. NW was supposed to have an improved offense with Preston Stone at QB and a tough D, but were outgained 421-237 by Tulane in the opener with Stone tossing 4 int's and losing a fumble (NW -5 TO). Last week, NW blew out FCS Western Illinois, 42-7 (-31'). The 'Cats will be without RB Porter the rest of the ssn, who left Saturday's game with a lower body injury. Oregon is favored -27' in the early Vegas line and we see no reason to doubt the Ducks after last wk's dominant performance.

Buffalo by 24 over KENT ST - The Visitor is 2-5 ATS but Buffalo has won & covered 3 straight conference openers (all as dog). Bulls have won & covered 2 straight in series including LY when UB (-24) won 43-7 (largest MOV in series history) with a 26-10 FD & 446-208 yd edge. Under 2nd year HC Pete Lembo is 4-0 SU & 3-1 ATS as a HF (failed to cover by 1 pt) including TY when UB (-38) beat FCS St Francis 45-6. The Flashes (-5) needed a GW KR TD to get past FCS Merrimack 21-17. Kent St is in the middle of a killer non-conf schedule off a 62-14 loss to #24 Texas Tech just covering as a 48.5 AD with Florida St & Oklahoma on deck. Buffalo hosts Troy next week, Buffalo held Minn to just 3.48 ypc in the opener while KS was only able to put up 2.6 ypc vs Merrimack (1.9 vs TT). Buffalo is a MAC contender this year and were upset by KS in '22, so there are still players who remember that game so we look for Buffalo to take care of business here.

MICHIGAN by 21 over Central Michigan - First meeting since '13. CMU is 0-4 vs UM (1-2 ATS) & lost the last 3 in '03, '06 & '13 by avg score of 48-11. The Chippewas are 6-30 vs Big Ten (2-8 SU & 5-4-1 ATS last 10 w/push last year at Ill). Mich won the last mtg in '13, 59-9, as 31'-pt fav. Mich has won 13 straight over the MAC since Toledo loss in '08 (9-4 ATS over that stretch, with 5 of last 6 going under Vegas total). Central's new HC Matt Drinkall was happy with what he inherited and they upset San Jose St on the road in the opener. Last week, CMU lost at Pitt, 45-17 (+21). Michigan's new QB Underwood is hitting 55% (393, 1-0). Michigan only led New Mexico, 27-17, in the 4Q in the opener, and last week Michigan, who missed LB Barham with a 1st half targeting suspension, lost at Oklahoma, 24-13 (+4'). HC Moore will begin his 2-gm susp. this week, so ex-Char. HC Biff Poggi will fill in. Early Vegas line has Mich. -27'. Mich. is 7-11-1 ATS as a HF the last 4 years and within a large Okla./Neb. sandwich. Central is 24-14-1 ATS as an AD but is on its 3rd straight road game. Little brother Central will be fired up for this, and the angles and situation say take the dog to cover.

Clemson by 3 over GEORGIA TECH - Massive ACC implications here for both teams. Clemson led LSU 10-3 at half in their opener but since then haven't been impressive. Last week they were -31 yet trailed Troy 16-0 2Q before pulling together and won 27-16. GA Tech QB Haynes King sat out last week's 59-12 (-37') win over Gardner-Webb. Backup QB Aaron Philo threw for 373. Clemson has won the last 9 meetings (7-1-1 ATS). They last met in '23 when Clemson was -14'. The Tigers led 42-7 and GT added two meaningless td's in the 4Q. Brent Key is 8-3 ATS vs ranked teams including 6 outright upsets and they lost to Georgia in 80T's last year. Clemson has the talent edge but we expect King back under center and Philo is a nice backup option should he get hurt again. Clemson is on a 2-8 ATS run dating back to last year and the Jackets always keep these games close.

AUBURN by 24 over South Alabama - Schools are separated by 222 miles but have never met. Auburn off to a 2-0 start. Their Week 1 win at Baylor (+1), 38-24, became more impressive after the Bears knocked off SMU in Dallas last weekend. Last Saturday, the Tigers handled Ball St, 42-3, as a 42'pt favorite. The SEC schedule begins next weekend at Oklahoma, which will also be an emotional return to Norman for QB Jackson Arnold who began his career as a Sooner. South Alabama hits the road for the first time this season. After beating Morgan St, the Jags were a failed 2pt conv in the final minute from taking Tulane (-13') into OT. They outgained the Green Wave and the trio of QB Bishop Davenport, RB Kentrel Bullock & WR Devin Voisin all played well. The Auburn D is hitting its stride, so this is a much tougher test. But with undefeated OU up next and Hugh Freeze 4-8 ATS here as a home fav, we think the backdoor could be wide against USA.

UConn by 17 over DELAWARE - These two were once conference rivals in the FCS as members of the Yankee Conference/A10 from 1986-'99. Delaware actually leads the series 20-7. Last week UConn (+7) led Syracuse 17-6 start of the 4Q. Cuse scored on a 53 yd td pass then went 80/10 td with :48 left. UConn tied the game with :01 left but Cuse won in OT. Delaware played at Colorado last week. They only trailed 10-7 but gave up a 21 yd td pass with :09 left in the 1H. The Hens lost 31-7 (+24). This is the first time Delaware has been a home dog under HC Ryan Carty. UConn is 3-1 as an AF under Mora. Huskies QB Joe Fagnano had a 23-4 ratio since the start of '24. UConn has won just 9 road games the last 10 years but after nearly upsetting Syracuse we think they will rebound here and we don't mind laying DD's.

Pittsburgh by 14 over WEST VIRGINIA - 108th edition of "The Backyard Brawl". Since 2007, 6 of 8 meetings have been decided by 7 points or less. Last 3 in Morgantown. Pitt is 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS, with all 3 going under the total (avg 33ppg). This is the Panthers' first road trip of the ssn. They beat Duquesne (+40'), 61-9, and Central Michigan (+20') last Saturday, 45-17. They outgained the Chips 464-217 but only led by 7 late 3Q. As a road fav, HC Pat Narduzzi is 15-4 ATS! This is WVU HC Rich Rodriguez's 1st against Pitt since 2007. His return to Morgantown hit a rough patch when the Mountaineers lost at Ohio (+3') 17-10, last wk. WVU was outgained 429-250 and averaged 2.6 ypc. Narduzzi's defenses create pressure and have 4 sacks in each of the first 2 gms. Plus, WVU's best off player Jaheim White is injured. Milan Puskar Stadium will be electric but we don't believe the Neers can handle Pitt's pressure and will fall by double digits.

TEXAS TECH by 21 over Oregon St - Teams mtg for first time since 1959. Texas Tech lost to the Pac-12's other tm, Washington St, last year 37-16. But this is a very different Red Raiders squad, and Oregon St has started slowly. TT has left no doubts in wins over Arkansas-Pine Bluff and Kent St by a combined score of 129-21. They're 1-1 laying big numbers with both gms going over the total. They also went over 600 yds in each gm. With a trip to Utah on deck, Oregon St presents a bigger challenge but not a serious one. The Beavers are 0-2 in HC Trent Bray's second year. They lost the opener to Cal (-2') who was using a true frosh QB and then fell to Fresno St (+1) in Saturday's home opener. They dominated in yds (+210) but had 2 costly picks and gave up 2 non-off td's. The backfield is solid with QB Maalik Murphy & RB Anthony Hankerson, but TT has not taken its foot of the gas. We have this game close to the opening Vegas line.

USC by 28 over PURDUE - This is USC's first trip to West Lafayette since '76 (USC 31-13 win). This is their first official meeting as B10 rivals. In last 10 season road openers, the Trojans are 6-4 SU & 3-7 ATS. In their last 11 true road games in diff time zones, USC is 4-7 SU & 2-9 ATS (7 straight ATS losses). Purdue trails the series 3-1 (won '67 Rose Bowl). The two teams last met in '98 (USC won 27-17 as 7-pt fav). The Boilers are 0-4 ATS last 4 B10 home openers. As home dog in league games, Purdue 8-20 ATS since '14 (0-4 LY). HC Riley is 9-21-1 ATS as an AF. USC was much better than their 7-6 record last yr - at 1 point they were just 5 plays away from being 11-0. USC opened strong with a 77-13 win over Missouri St. Last week, USC defeated Georgia St, 59-20 (-29') thanks to two long TD catches by Lemon. Purdue has a new HC in Barry Odom and opened with a 31-0 win over Ball St. Last week, Purdue defeated FCS So. Illinois, 34-17 (-20'), thanks to a nice game by RB Mckobee (126, 2 TD). Odom is the 1st Purdue HC to start 2-0 since 1918! Early Vegas line has USC -21. Purdue has practically a new team and are confident, but we believe USC will roll here.

SMU by 35 over MISSOURI ST - First meeting. Missouri St is hosting their first P4 team after moving up to the FBS this season. SMU is coming off a heartbreaking loss to Baylor where they led 38-24 mid 4Q. The Mustangs allowed the game tying td with :34 left then lost in 2OT's. Missouri St trailed Marshall 20-7 mid 3Q but their td with 2:12 left gave them a 21-20 victory. The Bears were throttled by USC in wk1 73-13 and allowed 597 yards. This is a huge sandwich for SMU, coming off Baylor with the Battle for the Iron Skillet vs TCU on deck. Mustangs are 8-4 ATS when favored by 20+. There is a huge talent edge for the Mustangs and normally the sandwich would lead us to go with the dog but SMU dominated teams after their one regular season loss last year so we expect a blowout.

MISSOURI by 21 over Louisiana - First mtg. This is Missouri's final non-conf gm before SEC play begins with a visit from South Carolina. Tigers moved to 2-0 SU & ATS with LW's 42-31 comeback win over rival Kansas (+6). Mizzou trailed by as much as 15 and as late 4Q but rallied behind new QB Beau Pribula and two 100-yd rushers. They outplayed the Jayhawks and were +369 yds and +15 FD's! A visit from Louisiana is a potential sandwich spot. Cajuns rebounded from Wk 1 loss to Rice (+10) with a win over McNeese (+19') 34-10. The defense has played well but the pass gm has struggled with just 174 yds in the first 2 gms. Plus, starting QB Walker Howard could be OFY and RfR Daniel Beale was 14-22 for 86 yds and 1 td vs McNeese. Missouri will stack the box to stop RB's Bill Davis & Zylan Perry. We have Missouri rolling by 3 td's in another high-scoring gm (Louisiana's L8 vs SEC & Mizzou's L3 vs SBC have gone over total).

Iowa St by 31 over ARKANSAS ST - Back half of home and home. Iowa St (-20') won LY, 52-7. Cyclones were +308 yds and held Red Wolves to ssn-low 182 yds and 12 FD's. ISU is off to a 3-0 start with quality wins over K-State and Iowa. LW's 16-13 defeat of the Hawkeyes snapped 6-gm home losing streak in the series. While the Iowa gm is always emotional and physical, Cyclones are on an 8-1 ATS run the gm after the Cy-Hawk rivalry. Arkansas St is 1-1. They covered the opener vs SEMO (+13'), 42-24, and lost LW to Arkansas (-23), 56-14. Red Wolves are rebuilding on D and allowed 630 yds to the Hogs (6 td passes allowed 1st 2 gms). The ISU offense has sputtered against P4 defenses, but it hung up 55 pts and 529 yds in Week 2 vs South Dakota so the potential is there to exploit weaker defenses. The Cyclones are off next week so no lookahead spot. ISU is locked in right now and we have them coasting in Jonesboro by more than 4 td's.

TEXAS by 38 over UTEP - Last met in '20 when Texas opened with a 59-3 (-43) win during the Covid season. Longhorns last 4 wins over UTEP are by 44 ppg (4-0 ATS). Texas bounced back from their loss to Ohio St last week by beating San Jose St 38-7 (-37) but they are 0-2 ATS. Manning threw 4 td passes. UTEP also bounced back from a week 1 loss to Utah State and beat UT Martin 42-17 (-6'). Miners QB Malachi Nelson was one of the nation's highest QB recruits out of

HS (Orig USC/Boise St). He has a 5-1 ratio and threw for 278 last week. Texas only has Sam Houston on deck so no look ahead here. However, Texas punted 6 times last week vs SJSt and the Longhorns are laying over 40 points here. We can't lay this kind of margin until we see Texas' offense click so our lean is with the underdog.

MIAMI, FL by 21 over Usf - Miami is 6-1 in the series and has won 4 straight SU & ATS. Last year Miami (-17) only led 22-15 at half but scored the final 28 points for a 50-15 win. The 'Canes upset Notre Dame at home in their opener and are only off Bethune Cookman. USF has pulled B2B upsets after beating both Boise St and Florida. The Bulls have to come up with a 3rd straight A+ performance against a team that physically dominated Notre Dame in the trenches. Miami QB Carson Beck has a 4-0 ratio and should take advantage of a USF D that allowed 279 pass ypg last year. Miami is laying over 2 td's and after pulling 2 outright upsets we expect the public to bet that down but the 'Canes are more talented and fresher.

Liberty by 2 over BOWLING GREEN - Flames are 5-2 SU & ATS vs MAC but LY (+4) lost to Buffalo 26-7 in the Bahamas Bowl. The Home team has won & covered both previous meetings including Liberty's (-8) 34-24 in '23's season opener but they needed a front door cover FG with 2:52 left. The Flames are 0-2 ATS TY failing to cover in the opener -25' vs Maine (28-7) and LW losing 34-24 to Jacksonville St as a 6 pt AF. Liberty never led and were outgained 536-290 as QB Gavin Wimsatt hit just 6-12-52 but rushed for 78 (1 td). RB Cam Cook (29-195, 2 td) had over half their offense. Under new HC Eddie George BG (-21) also failed to cover vs their FCS foe only beating Lafayette 26-7. LW against a tough Cincinnati, Bowling Green (+23') never fell behind the spread out scoring Cincy in the 2H and were only outgained 439-372 in a 34-20 loss. QB Drew Pyne threw for 29-34-274-1-0 on the road LW. Liberty is also just 1-6 their last 7 as an away favorite which has us leaning with the home dog.

Fau by 3 over FIU - FAU has dominated the Shula Bowl with 7 straight wins by 30.3 ppg (7-0 ATS)! The Owls played with a misleading loss to Maryland where they were only outgained 380-354 but were -6 TO's. Last week they put up 553 yards and beat FAMU 56-14. FIU was competitive with Penn St, only trailing 10-0 and outgained 190-151 at the half. Both teams are led by new HC's. FAU's Zach Kittley was OC at Texas Tech the last 3 years. FIU's Willie Simmons was a HC at Prairie View A&M & FAMU. FIU was 3-0 as a home dog last year but they are the favorite at presstime. FAU has the talent edge, led by LY's CUSA OFF POY Caden Veltkamp and we are going to follow series history and pick the Owls by a fg.

SOUTHERN MISS by 1 over App St - Start of the SBC ssn for both schools. Both tms lack experience entering 2025 and have 1st year HC's. App St is 2-0 SU & 1-1 ATS. After an impressive opener over Charlotte, 34-11 as 3pt fav, the Mountaineers only beat Lindenwood (+31'), 20-13. They had a 287 yd edge but turned the ball over 4 times. The offense has produced more than 500 yds in both gms behind SEC transfer QB AJ Swann and RB Rashod Dubinion. Southern Miss is 1-1 SU & ATS in HC Charles Huff's debut. The Eagles lost to Miss St, 34-17, as a 14pt dog before beating Jackson St (+13') 38-20. USM was just +41 yds in the win, with the passing attack ahead of the ground gm (3.4 ypc first 2 gms). Huff is the more experienced coach, with App St's Dowell Loggains in his first year. We have Southern Miss winning in Hattiesburg in a close game that could come down to the final possession.

OHIO ST by 35 over Ohio - The Bobcats are 0-7 all-time vs OSU (2-1 ATS in their most recent meetings in '99, '08, '10). Ohio has not faced a ranked opp since '16 (2-0 ATS that yr). Since '16, the Bobcats are 2-9 ATS and 2-8-1 ATS vs P4 opp. The schools are separated by 75 mi and have a bigger rivalry off the gridiron than on it. Since '18, OSU 24-17 ATS when favored by 20+ (3-4 LY). In their last 6 vs MAC, OSU 5-1 ATS & 5-1. Def. Nat'l Champ OSU opened #3 in the polls but beat Texas in the opener 14-7, despite being outgained 336-203. RfR QB Sayin became the first QB in 41 yrs to beat the No. 1 team in his first career start. Last week Ohio St trounced FCS Grambling St, 70-0 (-54'). Ohio finished last season with 30 or more points in 6 of its final 7 games. In its opener, Ohio U trailed Rutgers 31-14, but rallied back before losing, 34-31. Last week we cashed our underdog POW on Ohio who upset West Virginia 17-10 (+3') behind a nice game from QB Navarro (347, 3-1). Ohio State has Washington on deck for its first road game of the season & B10 opener. The early Vegas line has the Buckeyes -32'. OSU has not lost to an in-state opponent since 1921 (Oberlin, 7-6), and we expect that streak to continue another year.

VIRGINIA TECH by 4 over Old Dominion - ODU beat VTech in '18 & '22 but they've lost the last two meetings both SU & ATS. Last year the Hokies were -16' and won 37-17 with a 465-293 yd edge. VTech is 0-2 but has taken on two SEC foes in South Carolina and Vandy. Last week the Hokies led the Commodores 20-10 at half then Vandy scored the last 34 points. ODU is a quality team that returned 11 starters this year. They covered their opener at Indiana, only losing 27-14 (+23') despite getting outgained 502-314. Last week they crushed NC Central 54-6. HC Rahne is 21-14-1 as a dog with 12 outright upsets and they are 12-5 as road dogs since '22. VT desperately needs a win and we think they get it, but ODU is getting over a td and 15 of Rahne's 31 losses are by 7 or less.

ILLINOIS by 28 over Western Michigan - This is the second of two games vs the B10 for WMich in '25. WMU (-3) upset Illinois, 34-10, in their last meeting in '16, when they swept the reg season and won MAC title. Since '21, the Broncos are 1-8 SU & 3-6 ATS vs P4 opponents (beat Pitt, 44-41, in '21). Illinois leads series, 4-2, but lost the last meeting, 34-10, in 2016 as 3-pt fav. The Illini have covered just 1 of their last 7 vs MAC (beat CMU (-21) LY, 30-9, for a push). Five of those 7 meetings went under the Vegas total. Bielema is 7-11-1 ATS as a HF and Illinois has a huge B10 game vs Ind. on deck and is off a big game. Illinois is at least a TD better than last year's 10-3 squad. Illinois opened with a 32-3 win over WIU and last week Illinois defeated Duke, 45-19 (-2'). QB Altmeyer had a big game (296, 3-0) in the win, while the defense forced 5 turnovers! Western Michigan is in Year 3 for HC Lance Taylor. They trailed Mich St 21-0 at half and got an interception return for a TD in the final minutes to cover in a 23-6 loss. Last week, WMich took North Texas to OT, but lost 33-30 (+11'). Taylor is 5-6 ATS as an AD. In the early Vegas line, Illinois is favored -27'. In a sandwich game for Illinois, look for the Broncos to keep it closer than that.

Arkansas by 3 over OLE MISS

Arkansas (+) over OLE MISS - Underdog is 12-2 ATS in this series including 7 outright upsets since '11. Last year was a rare instance where the favorite covered with Ole Miss putting up 694 yards in a 63-31 (-7) win. Ole Miss is a much different team this year after losing Jaxson Dart who had a 29-6 ratio while new starter Austin Simmons only has a 3-4 ratio. Last week the Rebels trailed at Kentucky 10-0 2Q. Their offense sparked behind Kewan Lacy who ran for 138 and WR Harrison Wallace who had 4-117. Ole Miss led 30-20 and KY added a fg for a backdoor cover with :08 left. Ark is 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS after beating Alabama A&M and Arkansas St 56-14 (-23). Hogs QB Taylen Green is in the 2nd year of Bobby Petrino's system and already has thrown 10 td passes. Sam Pittman is 11-4 as an AD and 18-10-1 ATS vs ranked teams. He has also led Ark to 9 outright upsets including two last year. We like the Arkansas offense to put up numbers against an Ole Miss D that just allowed KY to put up 359 yards and Pittman gets another outright upset!

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 10 over Jacksonville St - First half of home-&-home. Georgia Southern is back in Statesboro after starting the szn with b2b trips to California. The Eagles were routed by Fresno St and USC, failing to cover either gm. Against the Trojans (-29') they were outgained 755-377 and lost 59-20. However, they're a different team at home, where HC Clay Helton is 13-5 overall and 8-3 ATS as a favorite. Jacksonville St has started well for 1st yr HC Charles Kelly. Gamecocks are 2-0 ATS, only losing by 7 to UCF (-20') and upsetting Liberty, 34-24, LW as 6pt dog. However, they were outgained 534-390 by the Flames and gave up three plays of 50+ yds. GS will expose the holes in the JSU D with veteran QB JC French and playmakers OJ Arnold and Auburn transfer Camden Brown (3 td catches). Despite the 0-2 start, we believe the Eagles are an SBC contender, and the overreaction to both tm's starts has created line value in favor of GS.

KENTUCKY by 30 over Eastern Michigan - EM is 0-1 Su & 3-7 ATS vs FCS foes. Kentucky is 2-0 in series (1-1 ATS) but needed a frontdoor cover td with :54 left in their last meeting to win 38-17 (-15). In their opener the Eagles (+14) only trailed Texas St 24-17 at HT but trailed 45-17 early 4Q scoring a td with :41 to only lose 52-27. Things got even worse for the Eagles LW as they lost outright to FCS Long Island 28-23 despite being a 22 pt HF. Kentucky opened the season with a 24-16 road win (-1) over a much tougher MAC foe Toledo. They are 7-3 ATS in non-conf games s/23. LW KY (+9) led #20 Ole Miss 10-0 and were tied 20-20 late 3Q but needed a backdoor cover FG w/:08 left to only lose 30-23. While KY QB Zach Calzada is day to day with a shoulder injury he has struggled this year avg just 117 ypg hitting just 47% with an 0-1 ratio. Usually teams step up the first week without their starting QB and with a bye on deck before a killer SEC schedule, look for the Wildcats to get their offense going no matter who starts. It could be a long day for the Eagles who are allowing 7.4 ypc facing a KY team avg 4.9 ypc.

LSU by 6 over Florida - LSU is out for revenge for their 27-16 (-3) loss to FL LY in The Swamp. Just when it seemed like Billy Napier had won enough to build some job security, one bad loss and a ridiculous schedule has him back on the hot seat. Florida was one of the nation's hottest teams to end '24, upsetting LSU and Ole Miss B2B games and won their last 4. They dominated FCS Long Island in the opener but were undisciplined last week and lost to USF 18-16. LSU upset Clemson on the road in the opener but were flat last week vs LA Tech and only won 23-7 as 37 pt home favorites. QB Nussmeier only has a 2-1 ratio and they only average 3.6 ypc. Napier has done his best work when Florida is an underdog. He is 14-6-1 as an away dog including 6-3 here. LSU's dominance over Clemson isn't as impressive after seeing Clemson struggle vs Troy. We won't call for the upset as LSU has a dominant defense and they are at home but Napier knows how to keep these games close.

NOTRE DAME by 7 over Texas A&M - A&M is out for revenge after losing the opener to ND last year. It was 13-13 4Q, ND went 86/8 td with 1:54 left then A&M was SOD and ND added a fg. Irish are fresh off a bye and two weeks ago lost to Miami 27-24 (-2'). A&M's offense has been impressive in their 2-0 start, beating UTSA 42-24 and Utah St 44-22. A&M gave up late 4Q td's in both games. QB Marcel Reed was banged up last week, but has a 7-0 ratio and should be good to go this week according to HC Elko. Since 2018 ND is 23-5 ATS when favored by single-digits and 11-2-1 ATS at home vs ranked teams. A&M is 3-12 ATS under Elko. The angles all clearly say to take Notre Dame but we think A&M is a good team and we have this right at the line.

East Carolina by 7 over COASTAL CAROLINA - First half of home-&-home, with ECU set to host in 2028. The Pirates are 1-1 but have covered both games. A late rally in the opener with NC St fell short, 24-17, but they covered the 14pt number and were only -10 yds. ECU rebounded last week to pound Campbell (+29'), 56-3, in a game they led 35-3 at HT (+384 yds). Pirates are a pass-first team behind QB Katin Houser and a deep receiving corps. CCU has also played an ACC opponent followed by an FCS visitor. Unlike ECU, they were pummeled by Virginia (-13'), 48-7, & outgained by 200 yds, and beat a bad Charleston Southern (+28') squad just 13-0. The pass gm was so inept vs the Bucs that HC Tim Beck benched QB MJ Morris in favor of Tad Hudson. Hudson went 3-5 for 37 yds and scrambled for a score. The Pirates are the more consistent team, particularly at QB, so we have them earning a road win by a td this Saturday.

LA TECH by 10 over New Mexico St - LT had won 6 straight as WAC rivals but NMSU is 2-0 SU/ATS since they joined CUSA. NMSU is 2-0 for the first time since 2014 after beating Tulsa 21-14 (+3'). Montana transfer QB Logan Fife has a 3-1 ratio. LT's D has picked up where they left off despite a new DC and losing 8 starters. Last year they allowed just 21 ppg and 308 ypg. This year they shutout FCS SELA in the opener then last week were +37 but held LSU to 365 yards and 23 points in a 16 pt loss. LT has put up just 31 pnts and 416 yards in 2 games. LT may make a change at QB which could spark the offense. LT is currently a 10 point favorite, which is exactly where we see this finishing.

IOWA by 42 over UMass - First meeting. The Minutemen are 0-8 all-time vs the B10 by an avg margin of 50-11 (1-6-1 ATS). In their last B10 meeting, UMass lost to Penn St, 63-0, in '23. Since 2017, UMass is 2-6 ATS in road openers. Since 2015, Iowa is 13-0 SU, 7-6 ATS and 7-5-1 to the over vs opponents from Group of 5 conf. When favored by 20+ pts, the Hawkeyes are 7-7 over last 14 games. Iowa has a new QB in Mark Gronowski who led SD St to a pair of FCS titles. They opened running for 310 yds vs Albany but only won 34-7. K Stevens had a career-long 55-yd FG. Last week, Iowa fell to rival Iowa St, 16-13 (+3), on a FG with 1:52 left. UMass has a new HC and were throttled by Temple at home in the opener, 42-10. Last week, UMass was upset by FCS Bryant, 27-26 (-14') - Bryant's 1st win over an FBS program EVER! UMass is 8-4 ATS as an AD the last 3 years and has a bye on deck. UMass may be without 9 starters this week, which will not help their chances. Iowa is off rival Iowa St and has its Big Ten opener at Rutgers on deck but the Hawkeyes need to get their offense going and we don't see a banged up UMass team presenting a challenge.

Navy by 17 over TULSA - Navy is 8-2 in the series but they haven't met since '22. The Middies are 5-0 SU/ATS when playing at Tulsa. Name comes in 2-0 but didn't cover last week vs UAB as

SITUATION PLAY OF THE WEEK.....STANFORD

3 td chalk, winning 38-24 and only had a 463-413 yd edge. Tulsa won their opener over Abilene Christian but last week they were favored at NMSU and lost 21-14 despite a 376-291 yd edge. The Golden Hurricane have a 1st year HC in Tre Lamb who was HC at ETSU and Gardner-Webb the last two years. Neither of those squads played against the option. Tulsa is 5-14-1 ATS as a home dog since '19. Navy is 15-8 ATS as an AF the last 10 years. Navy is laying 2 td's. The angles and the matchup both favor Navy so we give them a small lean.

TULANE by 3 over Duke - Duke QB Darian Mensah is up against his former squad. The Blue Devils outplayed #12 Illinois in the first half last week but they were -5 TO's and allowed 306 yards in the 2H in a 45-19 (+2) loss. Tulane has lost their last 3 against Duke but the last meeting was back in '15. The Green Wave are 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS. Last week they were -13 at South Alabama and led 33-17 but allowed 2 late td's and won by 2. The Green Wave already have a win over a P4 team, beating Northwestern 23-3 in the opener. Manny Diaz is 8-3 as an away dog while Jon Sumrall is 15-9 as a home favorite. We like both teams in their respective roles. The line opened with Tulane favored by 3 but has since flipped to Duke by -1. Hard to play against either team here but we like the home team in a close game.

UAB by 7 over Akron - UAB (-8) won only prior mtg 31-20 in '19. Blazers struggled in opener vs FCS Alabama St scoring a td w/1:19 left to win 52-42 as a 20' pt HF with just a 520-514 yd edge, LW UAB (+21) were tied 24-24 at Navy but lost were outscored 14-0 in 2H. Akron is just 4-18 SU & 5-17 ATS in non-con games since '19 (all wins vs FCS). That includes 2 shutout losses this year: 10-0 to Wyoming (UA +5) and 68-0 at Nebraska (UA +34). UAB has a trip to Tennessee on deck, while Akron has an FCS on deck. Akron top RB Sean Patrick (5.3 ypc) was knocked out in the 1H vs Wyoming but returned LW putting up 12-64 against a tough Nebraska defense. UAB is allowing 5.4 ypc including 49 ypc to Alabama St. They are also allowing 40 ppg, which should finally allow the Zips to get on the board. While UAB should win here they have opened as a DD favorite and we look for a Zips team that held Wyoming to 10 pts to keep it closer than that.

Air Force by 7 over UTAH ST - It's the start of the MWC schedule for both programs. Air Force is coming off a bye week and has played just one game. Falcons beat Bucknell (-32), 49-13, for their 6th straight cover going back to last season. Air Force is also 9-4 as a road favorite over the last 4 years, and HC Troy Calhoun believes this is a completely different team than the one that went 5-7 in 2024. First-year HC Bronco Mendenhall has split his first 2 games at Utah St but is 2-0 ATS. The Aggies beat UTEP (+5') at home in the opener, 28-16, and lost last weekend to Texas A&M, 44-22, as a 35pt dog. They were outgained 554-250 in College Station. Mendenhall is 6-1 SU & ATS vs AF during his career, including a 52-37 win LY as New Mexico's HC. However, he has a bigger rebuild in his first ssn at Utah St. Air Force is further along and well-rested, and we expect them to make it 7 consecutive ATS wins this weekend.

NEVADA by 7 over Middle Tennessee - This is first of B2B first meeting's vs CUSA schools for Nevada. The Wolf Pack are 1-1 SU/ATS after winning a close game over FCS Sacramento St last week. Their were 30 points scored in the 1Q then no scoring until Nevada's 36 yd IR td with 2:17 left that gave them their first lead. MT looked like an improving squad this year but they've gotten off to a rough 0-2 SU/ATS start including a loss to FCS Austin Peay in wk1 where the Blue Raiders put up just 153 total yards. They only trailed Wisconsin 14-10 at half last week and yards were nearly even then Wisky scored 4 2H td's and MT lost 42-10 (+29'). MT is now 2-12 ATS under Mason. Nevada is laying 9 points here which is a lot for a team that has lost their last 7 vs FBS teams. Not much desire to lean with either team but MT put up more fight and might actually have some value going forward with a veteran team so we lean with the dog.

ARIZONA ST by 7 over Texas St - Battle of 2 of the game's brightest young HC's -- ASU's Kenny Dillingham & Texas St's GJ Kinne. Texas St nearly won LY's Wk 3 mtg. Bobcats (-1) led by as much as 14, and were +53 yds but couldn't hold on in a 31-28 loss. Both tms were involved in upsets last weekend. Texas St (+5) beat a good UTSA team in San Antonio, 43-36, for their second straight cover to start 2025. Kinne loves the arm talent of RfR Brad Jackson whose 5 td passes have gone to Beau Sparks. Meanwhile, #12 ASU fell to Mississippi (+6), 24-20. Sun Devils fell behind 17-0, rallied back for a 20-17 lead but allowed Brenen Thompson to get behind the secondary for a 58yd td with 30 sec left. They have Baylor next to start the Big 12 sked. Texas St knows it can hang with the Sun Devils, and they're confident and more potent on offense this ssn. We see line value with the dog as the Bobcats keep this to within a single digit gm.

Minnesota by 6 over CALIFORNIA - These two havent met since '06 & '09 and Cal won both meetings. The Bears are 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS after beating Texas Southern 35-3. True freshman QB Jaron-Keawe Sagapolutele has been impressive, with a 3-1 ratio and hitting 69% completions. Minn is led by rR QB Drake Lindsey and the Gophers are 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS. Last week they slaughtered Northwestern St, who had lost 20 straight but won their opener. Minn led 59-0 with a 285-18 yd edge at half. They stopped the game mid 4Q with Minn up 66-0. This is a long trip for Minn but they do have a bye week on deck and last year they won at UCLA 21-17 (-4). HC Wilcox is 13-5 as a home dog but Fleck is 15-9-2 as an AF. We like the Gophers roster more so we are calling for the visitor to win by just under a td.

Boston College by 8 over STANFORD - This is a Coast to Coast ACC matchup with BC traveling all the way across country to play a conference game. These two last met in '01 with Stanford winning. It's a huge situational edge for Stanford as not only does BC have a long travel, but they finished last week's game vs Mich St late at night with the Eagles losing 42-40 in 2OT's. Stanford is 0-2 SU/ATS after losing to Hawaii and BYU on the road. It may be time for a change at QB after Oregon St transfer Ben Gulbranson only hit 50% for 109 and 1 int in 2 games. BC QB Dylan Lonergan is a Bama transfer and was really impressive last week, throwing for 390 and 4 td's. On paper BC clearly looks like the better team and they are favored by double-digits. However this game won't end until around 2 AM ET so BC may be running on fumes in the 4Q and we think Stanford keeps it closer than expected.

Defensive baseline remains solid (2 sk, 1 INT), and KC's poor 2/11 on 3rd is unlikely to repeat. PHI opened with three scripted TDs but was scoreless after halftime, finishing at 308 yds; PHI QB Hurts went 188 pass/62 rush, 2 TD, PHI RB Barkley 60 rush, and PHI LG Dickerson left (back). Trend note: PHI after a win by ≤4 is 1-2 SU/ATS. Upset call: Arrowhead + Mahomes/Kelce timing + Brown's chemistry fills the Worthy void if he can't go, the Chiefs will handle this one. **FORECAST: Kansas City by 7**

Washington vs GREEN BAY – Thursday – Series leans WSH 3-2 SU / 4-1 ATS vs GB, but short-week splits clash: WSH 0-3 SU/ATS on Thu (0-2 road) while GB 3-0 SU/ATS on Thu and home fav 4-1 SU/ATS (WSH away dog 4-3 SU, 4-2-1 ATS). Week 1: GB QB Love 16/22, 188, 2 TD, 0 INT; GB RB Jacobs 19-66-1; defense controlled RZs and game script. WSH QB Daniels 233-1-1, WSH WR Deebo Samuel 7-77 + rush TD, WSH RB Robinson 14-58-1; defense stacked a 4-sk day and held NYG 0/11 on 3rd. Monitor GB OL Tom and Banks (GTD)—if either sits, WSH EDGE pressure + simulated pressures under HC Kellen Moore could test protection on a short week. Conversely, GB's B2B home spot (3-0 SU, 2-1 ATS) and scripted efficiency with TE Kraft/Jayden Reed in the RPO/PA game travel well to Thursdays. Expect tempo and field position to matter early with both offenses leaning quick-game to mitigate rush. **Marquee Available at 12 Noon ET on Gameday!**

Cincinnati by 3 over JACKSONVILLE – Sunday, 1 p.m. ET – Recent series: CIN 3-0 SU (2-1 ATS) last 5 yrs. No. 1 overall picks at QB on both sides: CIN QB Joe Burrow (2020) vs JAX QB Trevor Lawrence (2021). WK1, CIN won a grinder at CLE despite 141-327 (-186) yds, going +2 TO with INTs by CIN S Dax Hill and CIN CB Cam Taylor-Britt; CIN DE Hendrickson 1.5 sk. Burrow 14/23 for 113 yds with a TD to CIN TE Noah Fant; CIN RB Chase Brown scored from 3 yards. JAX mauled CAR up front (378 total, 200 rush); JAX RB Etienne 16-143, JAX TE Brenton Strange 4-59-1, JAX EDGE Josh Allen 2 sk; monitor JAX WR Christian Kirk (hamstring). Trends: CIN closed LY 3-1 SU/ATS after a slow home start (3-5 SU/ATS overall at home), while JAX road 1-7 SU (5-3 ATS) LY. Slight nod to the home fav with takeover leverage and a likely volume uptick for Burrow.

Buffalo by 7 over NEW YORK JETS – Sunday, 1 p.m. ET – Divisional. BUF has won 3 straight vs NYJ (3-0 ATS) and is 8-1 SU (5-4 ATS) vs the division; 11-5 ATS last 16, and as a -4.5+ fav: 8-0 SU (6-2 ATS). They roll in off a wild SNF comeback—down 15 inside 4:00, BUF QB Allen 394-2-0 plus 2 rush TD led a 497-yd, 0-TO night with help from BUF WR Keon Coleman 8-112-1 and BUF TE Kincaid TD—momentum that travels. NYJ fell 34-32 when PIT hit a FG with 1:03 left; the comeback final drive came up short. NYJ QB Fields 218-1-0, 48 rush, 2 TD, NYJ RB Hall 19-107, NYJ WR Wilson 7-95-1. Jets on B2B home were 0-2 SU/ATS LY. Bottom line: Buffalo's turnover edge, higher offensive ceiling, and recent head-to-head run point to the road fav by a touchdown.

Pittsburgh by 6 over SEATTLE – 4 meetings in the past decade: PIT 2-2 (3-1 ATS). PIT QB Rodgers reminded doubters the "washed" talk never matched the numbers, then backed it up on the field LW: 22/30, 244, 4 TD, 0 INT, 0 team TO despite 4 sk, with late-sync strikes to PIT WR Calvin Austin III 4-70-1 and PIT TE Pat Freiermuth (TD); and PIT EDGE T.J. Watt getting in 1.5 sacks. SEA QB Sam Darnold was turnover-free (150, 0 TD, 0 INT), but the offense finished at 230 total yds; SEA WR Jason Smith-Njigba 9-124 stood out while the RBs totaled 67 rush yds (SEA RB Walker III 10-20, 2.0 ypc; WR Charbonnet 12-47, 3.9). Context on PIT's 182 rush yds allowed: that was boosted by NYJ QB Fields' legs—Darnold isn't that threat type and with SEA having subpar play at RB it shouldn't duplicate. Trends lean home field (PIT home 4-2, 5-1 ATS; SEA away 2-0 SU but 0-2 ATS). It's one game, but Rodgers looked anything but washed; if he keeps spinning it like this, the Steelers are a team to keep an eye on. The Seahawks travel to the east coast and the with their pass D being the weak point we expect the Steelers to exploit it.

LA Rams by 6 over TENNESSEE – Trend board: LAR as a -3+ fav 10-0 SU (7-3 ATS); road 5-1 SU (6-0 ATS); TEN at home 0-8 ATS (1-7 SU) LY. Week 1, LAR played clean, turnover-free football (296 yds, 0 TO); LAR QB Stafford 21/29, 245-1-0 hitting 10 targets; LAR WR Puka Nacua 10-130, LAR WR Davante Adams 4-51, LAR RB Kyren Williams 18-66-1, LAR TE Davis Allen TD. TEN mustered 133 yds with 6 sk allowed—TEN QB Cam Ward struggled, TEN RB Tony Pollard 18-60, TEN WR Calvin Ridley 4-27; all points were FGs. Historical note: LAR 0-6 ATS vs TEN, but only two meetings under McVay (1-1 SU, 0-2 ATS). With L.A.'s efficiency edge and Tennessee's stalled offense/OL issues, Rams should control this and get the road win by a score.

San Francisco by 3 over NEW ORLEANS – Third meeting in 5 years (1-1 SU/ATS). Week 1, SF owned the yardage and pressure edge at SEA (384-230, +154; 4 sk), with SF QB Purdy 277-2-2 and splash plays from SF WR Ricky Pearsall 4-108; run game modest (119, 3.3 ypc). Injury watch looms: SF TE Kittle (IR, hamstring) and SF QB Purdy (shoulder/roe, uncertain), plus a kicker reset (Moody out, vet Peneiro in). Scheduling note: SF handled B2B road last year (2-0 SU/ATS). NO moved the ball (315 yds, 1 sk allowed, 0 TO) but were undone by 9 penalties and drops; NO RB Kamara 11-45-1, NO QB Rattler 214-0-0. Trend: Saints as home dog 0-4 SU (1-3 ATS). Narrow nod to the road fav on trench and discipline edges.

Miami by 3 over NEW ENGLAND – Divisional matchup with MIA QB Tagovailoa dominating at 7-0 vs NE; Dolphins are 4-0 SU (3-1 ATS) at home and 3-1 SU/ATS off a loss, while NE away is 0-3 SU (1-2 ATS). Week 1 snapshots: NE moved it but stalled (336 yds, 1-for-3 RZ) with a fluky team TD on a goal-line fumble; NE QB Maye 287-1-1, 4 sk, WR Kayshon Boutte 6-103, TE Hunter Henry TD. MIA never found rhythm at IND (211 yds, 2 TO, 3 sk); QB Tagovailoa 133-1-2, WR Tyreek Hill 4-40, RB De'Von Achane 7-55, and LT Terron Armstead exited (knee). Series edge for Tua plus Miami's home/spot trends point to the home fav, we think MIA will bounce back from wk1 and take care of business in New England.

Baltimore by 10 over CLEVELAND – AFC North clash with CLE QB Joe Flacco returning to Baltimore. Cleveland's offense looks and feels different with Flacco—more like that late-2023 rhythm: 290-1-2 last week with both picks off tipped drops the WRs aren't helping him any not to mention a missed XP and FG. CLE TE Harold Fannin Jr. had a day (7-63-1), Flacco also found WR Jerry Jeudy 5-66; and a defense that held CIN QB Burrow to 113 yds. It's still a divisional grinder, but the Browns' rush game was a non-factor (49 rush yds) and RB Juddkins is still up in the air so we might see more short passes to RB Sampson. BAL talent edge is hefty: RB Derrick Henry 18-169-2, QB Lamar Jackson 209-2 pass / 70 rush, and they come in angry after Buffalo's late comeback despite 432 total yds. Trends: BAL 7-0 SU (6-1 ATS) as 10+ pt fav, CLE 0-9 SU (1-8 ATS) as 10+ pt dog since 2016, series 3-3 (CLE 4-2 ATS). Expect a tighter feel than the number early, but the Ravens will be focused after the heartbreak loss they experienced in Buffalo.

Arizona by 6 over CAROLINA – Trend split: ARI 5-1 SU/ATS at home and 2-0 SU/ATS as a home fav, while CAR is 2-16 SU (5-13 ATS) on the road since 2023—through the series history leans CAR 7-1 SU/ATS. Week 1, ARI QB Murray 21/29, 163, 2 TD, 0 INT worked clean red-zone drives with ARI WR Marvin Harrison Jr. 5-71-1, and the Cards' front produced 5 sk. CAR allowed 378 yds to JAX with 200 rush; CAR QB Bryce Young 154-1-2 (40 rush), CAR RB Chuba Hubbard 89 scrm, TD. Given Carolina's 2 INT / 10 pts in JAX versus Arizona's turnover-free win, the error margin tilts to the Cards at home.

Indianapolis by 1 over DENVER – Third meeting in five years, series split 1-1 SU/ATS. Week 1, DEN strangled TEN (317-133 yds, 6 sk), but DEN QB Nix 17-61-2 kept it dicey; helpers: DEN RB Dobbins 16-63-1, DEN WR Sutton 6-61-1, DEN RB RJ Harvey 6-70 (50-yd burst). The Broncos helped some of us experience the first bad beat of the season: DEN HC Sean Payton passed on a 50+ yd try for DEN K Will Lutz (money from distance), went for it, and Bo Nix failed to complete the down, ultimately Denver didn't cover -8.5 (unless you grabbed the early -7.5) Besides that DEN was very underwhelming on offense. In a different story IND rolled MIA (418-211 yd diff, 0 TO): IND QB Daniel Jones 22/29, 272-1-0, IND RB Jonathan Taylor 71, IND WR Michael Pittman Jr. 6-80-1; D logged 3 sk. Trends: DEN after a home W 2-6 SU/ATS; IND 7-2 SU (6-3 ATS) at home, and in a B2B home spot they've been live (2-1 ATS as a dog). The Colts might be in a spot for a letdown after a big win but we'll give the edge to Indy on efficiency and ball security.

Atlanta vs MINNESOTA – SNF – Recent series leans purple: MIN 6-1 SU/ATS vs ATL, but there are balancing factors. ATL QB Michael Penix Jr. 298-1-0 + rush TD in his debut, ATL RB Bijan Robinson 124 scrm yds, and the D held TB to 3.7 ypc; kicker is a subplot (ATL K Koo under review after the late miss), and ATL WR Drake London (AC joint) is DTD. Trend board tilts MIN (ATL dog 0-4 SU/ATS; road 1-4 SU/0-5 ATS; after a loss 1-4/0-5 ATS), yet ATL 5-3 ATS as a 4+ dog. MIN QB J.J. McCarthy flashed late-game moxie (three 4Q TDs) but the Vikings still finished at 254 yds while allowing 317 to CHI; OL took a hit with OG Ezraa Cleveland (ankle). Prime-time stage, rookie QBs in the spotlight—plenty of ways this one can swing.

Tampa Bay vs HOUSTON – MNF – Back-to-back road spot for TB where they're 2-0 SU/ATS, and they've won 4 of their last 5 away. Week 1, TB QB Baker Mayfield 167-3-0 played clean, TB WR Emeka Egbuka 4-67-2 provided the splash, and the defense tightened in the RZ despite allowing near-300 pass yds; health to watch with TB LT Tristan Wirfs (ankle). HOU returns home off a one-score loss with a strong home response profile (6-2 SU after a home L): HOU QB C.J. Stroud 19/27 for 188 moved it efficiently until a late deep INT, HOU RB Nick Chubb 13-60 (4.6) gave balance, and the front produced pressure (HOU DE Will Anderson Jr. 1.5 sk; 3 sk allowed by LAR). Series note: rare meeting (one in last 5 yrs), HOU got the win while TB grabbed the cover. Clean turnover margins and red-zone finishing loom large in a matchup where both teams showed complementary flashes in Week 1.

Los Angeles Chargers vs LAS VEGAS RAIDERS – MNF – This divisional matchup has trends on both sides: LAC 6-1 SU/ATS as an away fav and 3-1 SU/ATS vs LV; LV 5-1 SU (6-0 ATS) at home on Monday, while LAC is 2-2 SU (3-1 ATS) away on Monday and LV is 0-5 SU (2-3 ATS) as a home dog. Week 1 yardage was nearly even: LAC 394 total yds vs LV 389. Personnel form: LAC QB Justin Herbert 318-3-0 with WR Quentin Johnston 5-79-2 and WR Keenan Allen 7-68-1 (team 0 TO, 3 sk allowed); LV QB Geno Smith 362-1-1, WR Jakobi Meyers 8-97, WR Tre Tucker 2-54-1 (run game 56 yds, 4 sk allowed with DE Maxx Crosby leading the rush). Add the return trip from São Paulo for LAC against the Allegiant prime-time environment for LV, and you've got a pass-protection and red-zone execution game. **Remember on Monday Nights you can get a \$back+ guarantee!
