Hokies have been dominant, beating VMI by 70 then LW won 44-21 vs Old Dominion. QB Grunemeyer has a 4-0 ratio and is hitting 77%. Last week we used the Over 51.5 in MD vs UConn as our 4★ Totals GOM. The Terps won 38-14 but settled for a fg after reaching the UConn1 at the end of the half and missed a 37 yd fg that would have given more of our customers the win. But the backfield is new and the offense worked out some kinks in last wk's 52-7 win over UT Martin. Virginia made an early statement by routing NC St (+4) with a 413-168 edge in yds before handling Norfolk St last week 59-3. TEXAS TECH by 7 over Houston - Since '09 loss, TT 7-0 SU & 6-1 ATS vs Houston. Red Raiders have won 5 straight here and are 4-0 SU & ATS in B12 home openers for HC McGuire. McGuire also 15-8-1 ATS as a HF in Lubbock. TT 2-0 but 0-2 ATS with wins over Abilene Christian and Oregon St that raised more questions than answers. Houston has covered both road openers under HC Fritz. These schools already have common opp in the Beavers. TT won 35-24 (-120 yds!) on road while Houston won 33-20 at home (+131 yds). In his return from last yr's injury, TT QB Will Hammond has just a 2-1 ratio. Cougars have an edge at QB with Conner Weigman and HC with Willie Fritz who's building UH into legit Big 12 contender. Lubbock will be rocking on a Friday but TT isn't blowing out tms like last year and Houston has the talent to stay within a score.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 19TH

DELAWARE by 4 over Coastal Carolina - First mtg and first half of home & home, with Delaware visit Coastal Carolina in '29. Blue Hens 1-1, opening with 42-7 win over Merrimack (+31) before last wk's 35-26 loss at Vanderbilt (-20). They were -1 yd vs Vandy and led at HT. Delaware 43-12 SU at home since '17 including outright upsets of UConn and LaTech in '25. The offense is potent with QB Nick Minicucci, RB Jo Silver and 3 starting OL back. Coastal Carolina 1-1 SU & 2-0 ATS. In the 31-24 loss to West Virginia, HC Ryan Beard's debut, they knotted the Neers at 413 yds and easily covered as 21pt dog. Beard brought QB Deuce Bailey over from Missouri St and he already has a 6-0 ratio. Blue Hens maintain their edge at home with a close win.

Arizona St by 7 over Kansas - This is the inaugural "Union Jack Classic" and first-ever CFB gm at London's Wembley Stadium! In only other mtg, ASU (-2) beat Kansas 35-31, on td pass with :16 left. HC Kenny Dillingham is 10-5-1 ATS as a favorite with the Sun Devils. ASU is looking to bounce back from a 48-20 loss at Texas A&M. Game was much closer than the final score with ASU trailing 24-20 start of 4Q before allowing 2 late pick-6's. Sun Devils were +114yds! Kansas is also looking to rebound after losing to an SEC foe. Jayhawks lost at home to rival Missouri, 38-21, and were

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outgained 469-255. QB Isaiah Marshall was just 13-30 for 168 yds, 2 td's & 2 int's in his first big test. Dillingham has embraced this trip and has the better QB in Cutter Boley (8-2 ratio).

PENN ST by 40 over Buffalo - Penn St is 3-0 SU/1-2 ATS vs UB but covered their last mtg in '19 45-13 as a 31 pt HF. Nittany Lions have won last 14 vs MAC straight up (10-4 ATS) only once allowing over 14 pts. Bulls are 1-12 vs Big Ten tms since '02 going 10-3 ATS. LW Penn St (-24) was up 27-14 4Q before allowing a backdoor cover td with 1:56 left. LW Buffalo (+10) trailed FIU 21-6 HT & 33-14 4Q and after getting within 33-20 were int'd on a 4th & 10 allowing FIU to run out the final 3:26. HC Matt Campbell is 0-3 ATS as a HD of 28+ but should keep it close to the line.

OHIO ST by 55 over Kent St - Ohio St has won & covered all 3 mtgs incl a 66-0 win as a 31 pt HF in their last mtg in '14. LW Kent St (-10) trailed Wofford 15-14 HT & into 4Q before scoring 22 unanswered. Kent St opened the season with a 57-0 loss at South Carolina as a 35' pt AD and with their MAC opener on deck will concentrate on getting out of this game as healthy. LW Ohio St (+1) led Texas 23-3 into 4Q but up just 23-17 missed a would-be game clinching 37 yd FG & allowed GW td with :25 left to lose 24-23 but covered. Buckeyes beat MAC foe Ball St 56-3 as a 50' pt HF in the opener. Now after a heartbreaking loss may take their frustrations out here as they don't want to show any weakness still #6 in AP poll.

CLEMSON by 10 over North Carolina - Bill Belichick and Dabo Swinney meet for the 2nd time. Clemson has won the last 7 mtgs (6-1 ATS) including last year 38-10 (-14). UNC is 2-0 including a win over TCU in the opener and last week they beat FCS ETSU 35-3. They held TCU to 281 yds and we think the offense is improved under QB Billy Edwards. The Tigers were dismantled in the opener by LSU, outgained 644-145 and LW they had a lackluster 22-7 (-20) win over GA Sthrn. True frosh Tait Reynolds could get his first start if Christopher Vizzina isn't ready to go (inj). Clemson had just 347 yds and was 2-14 on 3rd down. Clemson has lost 6 of their last 7 home games vs P4 foes and NC's defense is stout enough to keep this close.

MINNESOTA by 21 over Akron - First mtg. Gophers are 11-1 SU but just 5-7 ATS vs MAC teams. Zips are 2-0 ATS only losing to Wake Forest 38-16 (+27) & beating Robert Morris 45-10 (-27). Minnesota is 1-1 SU & ATS beating FCS EIU 59-7 as a 42' HF but LW as a 1 pt HD were manhandled 38-13 by Miss St. Akron is led by QB Broughton who is avg 168 ypg (80%) with a 4-0 ratio & leads with 153 ypg rush (5.7). Minn is led by QB Lindsey with 272 ypg (69%) with a 1-0 ratio (-6 rush) but their leading rush RB Taylor has just 71 yds (3.6). While Minn should win this game, they have their B10 opener on deck and an improved Akron team should keep it under the spread.

KANSAS ST by 24 over Tulane - In last mtg in '24, KSU rallied from down 20-10 on road to win, 34-27, on 60yd FR td in 4Q. LTH in '22, Tulane (+14) pitched 2H shutout in 17-10 upset. This is a battle of 1st yr HC's, K-State's Collin Klein and Tulane's Will Hall. Wildcats 2-0 SU & ATS with wins over Nicholls and Washington St by 75-10. They throttled plucky Wazzu, 34-7, with a 487-166 edge in yards! The Hall era has started a disappointing 1-1 SU & 0-2 ATS. The Green Wave answered a listless 17-3 loss at Duke (outgained 381-258) with a 28-24 win over South Alabama (+9) but were -12 fd's/-54 yds and needed a late 4Q td to avoid the home upset. The Duke loss dropped Hall's career mark as an AD to 7-12 ATS. KSU keeps rolling with a blowout win at home.

Georgia by 28 over ARKANSAS - Georgia is 6-0 SU all-time playing at Arkansas and they last met in '21. UGA was laying over 40 pts in each of their first 2 games but they covered both easily. Ark didn't look good against North Alabama 2 wks ago, winning 31-14 as 40' pt chalk. Last week the Hogs were beaten soundly by Utah 43-10 (+12'). Things don't get any easier against Georgia. The Dawgs are only 3-8 ATS as AF but we love the coaching edge here. Georgia will be hungry for their SEC opener and Silverfield was only 19-29 ATS vs conf foes while at Memphis. This will be a "welcome to the SEC" moment as Georgia wins by 4 td's.

IOWA ST by 31 over Bowling Green - First mtg since '79. Iowa St on 8-2 ATS run gm after facing rival Iowa. BG has covered 6 of L/7 vs Big 12 foes, losing to Cincy in '25, 34-20, as a 23pt dog. New Cyclone HC Jimmy Rogers is 1-1 SU & ATS and coming off a solid effort in his 1st Cy-Hawk Series. Iowa St only lost 16-13 as a 14pt AD and were -29yds. The offense is a work in progress (just 303 yds vs FCS SEMO) but the D has a ton of potential. After going 4-8 in his debut, Falcon HC Eddie George is already 0-2 after losing the opener to Tarleton St (-98 yds) and last wk at Nebraska, 56-7 (-377 yds). BG is also having offensive issues so we're not expecting many points, though this is a great spot for ISU and QB Jaylen Raynor to find some offensive rhythm.

TEXAS ST by 10 over North Texas - New UNT HC Neal Brown 20-13 as an AD including covering the opener vs Indiana. Mean Green (+40) lost 52-16 and were +2 yds vs Hoosiers. In last wk's home opener with UNLV, few Wk 2 tms were more impressive. As a 3'pt HD, UNT won, 44-6, and were +143 yds and +4 TO's. QB Tayven Jackson & RB Jaheim White have been key portal pickups. Texas St didn't fare as well in their opener vs the P4, losing to Texas (-29), 59-7. In their home opener vs UTSA, they lost 31-26 (+83 yds) but were -3 TO's and gave up winning td with :14 left. Bobcats have QB Brad Jackson and plenty of weapons. TO's played a role in last wk's outcomes. This wk, Texas St will protect the ball and hand the UNT its 1st loss of the ssn.

WISCONSIN by 21 over Eastern Michigan - Wisconsin is 4-0 SU but 2-2 ATS vs EMU. LTH ('21) EM (+26) gave up a front door cover td with 4:16 left to lose 34-7. Badgers are 38-1 vs MAC teams but have lost L/3 ATS. Badgers (+21) only trailed Notre Dame 13-10 HT but were outscored 28-0 in 2H. LW Wisc (-42) vs FCS foe Western Illinois never got ahead of the spread leading just 23-10 HT only won 36-9. Eagles after winning & covering their opener EM has dropped L/2 SU & ATS. That includes LW loss to instate foe Mich St losing 35-7 as a 17' pt AD. Badgers have their conf opener at Penn St on deck and giving over 3 td's might be a bit much here.

VANDERBILT by 7 over NC State - These two last met in '16 when NCSt won 41-17 (-5). Wolfpack were left for dead after poor performance vs Virginia in the opener when they put up 168 yds and 8 pts. They left no doubt last week though, beating Richmond 73-0 and they put up 734 yards. Vandy only beat Austin Peay 28-9 (-29) in the opener then last week vs Delaware they scraped by 35-26 (-21). 5* True frosh QB Jared Curtis came off the bench and ran for 3 td's. Clark Lea was money with Pavia at QB (18-7-1 ATS) but they are 0-2 so far this year. This is the week they turn to Curtis which will spark the Commodores and they move to 3-0. Vandy is 10-6 ATS at home and 3-0 ATS vs the ACC while NCSt is 0-6 ATS vs the SEC and 9-18-1 ATS as an away dog!

MISSOURI by 20 over Troy - Missouri 6-0 SU & 5-1 ATS last 6 vs Sun Belt. Troy is 2-22 vs SEC, beating LSU in '17 as a 3-td dog. This is Trojans' road opener, and they're 8-4 ATS as an AD under 3rd yr HC Gerad Parker. Parker is 11-4 ATS as an AD. Troy 2-0 SU but 0-2 ATS. They were -31 yds in 24-21 win over Sam Houston and only beat FCS Alabama St (+23), 34-17. Missouri is off emotional win at Border War rival Kansas and begins SEC play next wk at Miss St so this has massive sandwich game potential. New QB Austin Simmons has been sharp so far (75%, 7-0 ratio). Trojans have covered 4 str as a dog of 20+ pts, 3 with Parker as HC (lost to Clemson by 11, JMU by 17 and Iowa by 17 L2Y). Trojans will maintain that trend with Mizzou in a lookahead spot.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over Wyoming - Home Team & Favorite is 2-0 SU & ATS in regular ssn mtgs. Last met in '17 Potato Bowl Wyoming (-3) led by Josh Allen won 37-14. In their opener Wyoming (+3) only trailed 14-13 3Q but lost 35-13 at Colorado St. LW the Cowboys (-23) trailed FCS Northern Colorado 13-7 in 4Q but pulled out a 21-13 win. In their opener CM (+10) trailed MTW foe New Mexico 35-0 into 4Q losing 38-7. LW CM (-19) trailed FCS Colgate 10-0 HT & 10-6 4Q before pulling out a 13-10 win. With 2 struggling teams we will give the home team the edge.

TOLEDO by 10 over Temple - Former MAC foes, Rockets are 6-1 SU & 4-2-1 ATS vs Temple winning & covering L/2. Last met in '15 Boca Raton Bowl, Toledo (+2) won 32-17. Owls (-14) in their opener vs FCS Rhode Island only led 17-14 2Q before pulling away for a 38-14 win. LW Owls (+24) trailed Penn St 27-3 4Q before getting the backdoor cover on a 75 yd td drive w/1:56 left vs Penn St backups. In their opener the Rockets (+10) actually led at Mich St 20-19 before falling 30-20. LW Toledo (-36) trailed 3-0 but led 35-3 HT & 56-3 into 4Q in a 63-10 win. Temple is just 1-6 SU & ATS in road openers but won at UMass LY. Rockets are 22-3 SU & 16-9 ATS in the Glass Bowl s/'22 including winning 7 straight (7-0 ATS). So we will take the home team.

LOUISVILLE by 4 over Smu - These two last met in '24, SMU pulled the road upset 34-27 against #22 L'ville. SMU shot themselves in the foot repeatedly at FSU 2 wks ago but still won the game 27-24 w/a 585-324 yd edge. They crushed a Top 10 FCS team in UC Davis 56-10 last week. L'ville's QB Lincoln Kienholz was impressive vs Ole Miss as he led a 14 pt comeback but lost in OT. They also won easily LW vs FCS Villanova LW 59-13. SMU allowed FSU's RB Kromah to rush for 116 and now they face L'ville's dangerous duo of Isaac Brown and Keyjuan Brown, plus Kienholz is a dangerous runner himself. Cards were 1-7 as a HF LY but were also 8-3 the two years prior. SMU is 3-7 as a road dog. SMU has already shown they can be mistake prone on the road so we like Louisville, who is 15-6 SU at home, by over a fg.

CINCINNATI by 17 over Miami, Oh - 129th Battle for the Victory Bell (at Paul Brown Stadium). Cincinnati has won 17 of last 18 meetings (11-7 ATS) with their only loss in '23 but are just 1-2 ATS s/'22. Last met in '24 when Bearcats (-3) won 27-16 at Miami. Cincy is 2-0 SU & ATS beating Boston College 34-15 (-7) and LW cruising to a 62-10 win (-36) over FCS Western Carolina. In their opener, Miami (+16) trailed Pitt 21-0 2Q, 31-14 HT in a 59-14 loss being outgained 646-289. LW RedHawks (-31) led FCS Holy Cross 42-0 HT and with their backups in early won 45-7. Miami QB McComb had 241 yds pass (1 td) vs Pitt & hit 13-13 for 234 vs Holy Cross with 3 pass td & 1 rush td. Cincy QB French has hit 31-38-322 with a 3-0 ratio with 108 rush (6.1) & 3 rush td in 2 gm. Despite Cincy having their B12 opener on deck we look for the Bearcats to cover here.

MICHIGAN by 42 over Utep - Michigan was left for dead after they "won" against Western Michigan but last week was a different story when they beat Oklahoma 17-10. We still have concerns about the offense that is putting up 270 ypg and Bryce Underwood's passing isn't pretty but one thing is for sure, the defense is legit. UTEP already lost 51-0 at Oklahoma in week 1. They looked good last week, beating TX Southern 51-10 but they are looking forward to more winnable games down the road. Whittingham is 5-3 ATS when laying 30+ in non conf. Michigan has Iowa on deck but a shutout is likely here.

Usc by 21 over Rutgers - USC making their first trip to Piscataway. Only prior meeting was in '24, USC won 42-20 (-14). Rutgers had their chances last week against Boston College but lost 28-21. USC is already 3-0 and they've led all 3 games by 25+ points but allowed late td's vs SJSt and Louisiana. QB Maiaava already has a 10-1 ratio. Rutgers is 0-4-1 ATS as a 2 td Home Conf Dog but USC is 0-5 as a 2 td away conf favorite. Rutgers QB AJ Surace got his first start LW for inj'd Dylan Loneragan and threw for 230 yards and 3 td's but also 4 int's. Neither team plays well in these roles and this isn't a game we feel strong about.

TEXAS A&M by 21 over Kentucky - A&M won the only meeting as SEC foes back in '18, 20-14 (-5) in College Station. Aggies only led Arizona St 24-20 to start then got two defensive td's in the 4Q and won 48-20 (-14). A&M was outgained 369-255. KY led Bama 17-13 at half last week and was shutout in the 2H of a 45-17 (+10) loss. KY was 1-14 on 3rd down and finished with just 209 yards. This is A&M's 3rd straight home game while KY is playing their first road game under Will Stein. Mike Elko was only 4-11 ATS at home in '24-'25 but they've covered both games so far this year. 'Cats DC Jay Bateman was DC at A&M the last two year but A&M has a big experience edge, the coaching edge, are at home and have the more talented team. Aggies get their 3rd straight cover.

UTAH by 24 over Utah St - 114th mtg of the Battle of the Brothers with the Beehive Boot at stake. Utah has won 15 of L/16 (lost, 27-20, in '12). Utes won last mtg on road, 38-21, in '24 but are just 1-4 ATS L/5 and 1-4 ATS L/5 at home. Aggies just 2-9 SU but 9-2 ATS last 11 vs P4 opp. Utah has started fast in HC Morgan Scalley's debut. They're 2-0 SU & ATS after cruising past Arkansas (+13) 43-10. The offense has scored 109 pts and has playmakers in the backfield. Utah St is 0-2. They threw 4 int's and lost the opener to Idaho St (+14) despite being +166 yds. But last Saturday, they pushed Washington (-26) to the brink before bowing 16-14. They only allowed 249 yds but the QB's have already thrown 7 int's in 2 gms! HC Bronco Mendenhall 5-1 ATS here as an AD and 3-0 ATS as a DD dog. Utah begins Big 12 schedule next week with a trip to Iowa St.

LIBERTY by 17 over Ball St - Only prior mtg was in 2010, Liberty won 27-23 (+13). Ball St moved to 1-1 SU/ATS after a 41-17 win over FCS Stony Brook. Liberty didn't have nearly as easy a time with their FCS foe last week only beating Gardner-Webb 24-23. QB Purdie was benched in favor of WV transfer Jaylen Henderson who threw the GW 54 yd td pass with 2:34 left. Flames outgained James Madison 321-291 in the opener. Ball St is 2-6 as an AD under Mike Uremovich and they've lost 10 straight road games and they haven't won a road non-conf game since 2016 (18 str losses)! Chadwell is 16-4 SU at home but only 3-8 ATS as a HF the last 3 years. Henderson will give Liberty a spark on offense and the Flames win by 2 td's.

DUKE by 13 over Stanford - The smart kids meet for the first time as ACC foes. They last met in '12 Stanford won 50-13. This is the first of 5 games that Stanford is playing in the ETZ. Stanford is fresh off a bye which is huge considering they were w/o 3 starting OLvs Miami 2 wks ago. Duke has now won 6 straight going back to last year after upset win at Illinois, 31-27 (+5). QB Walker Eget threw 3 td passes and RB Nate Sheppard has rushed for 374 yards in 2 games. Eget was injured late and depth is a concern so keep an eye on his status. Duke hasn't been a

DD home ACC favorite since l/'17. Manny Diaz is only 2-7 ATS as a DD HF vs FBS foes but the line is only 9' at press time.

INDIANA by 48 over Wku - Hoosiers are 5-0 SU/2-3 ATS vs WKU. This is WKU's 3rd straight road game. They've lost at Nevada 49-14 (-2) and 70-20 (+40) at Georgia last week. Now they face the National Champs. Indiana wasn't all that impressive in the opener despite a 52-16 win over North Texas, actually getting slightly outgained. They are off a 55-0 win over FCS Howard where they allowed just 55 yards. After this beatdown WKU can't wait to play FCS' Mercyhurst next week. Indiana will have Northwestern on deck but Cignetti won't have sympathy for WKU's brutal schedule.

BAYLOR by 16 over Louisiana Tech - LT 1-20 vs Big 12 (beat OklSt in '02) and Sonny Cumbie is 0-7 vs P4 opp. However, the 5th yr Bulldog HC is 6-1 ATS in those gms. S/'23, Baylor 5-8-1 ATS as a HF and 3-4 ATS as a DD fav. Bears lost opener to Auburn in Atlanta, 17-16. They were +47 yds and came up inches short on a 2pt try for the win. The D played well and QB DJ Lagway got his 1st start, though he missed last wk vs Prairie View A&M (backups threw 3 int's). LT beat NW St (+44) in Wk 1 and then lost at LSU (-35), 45-14. Bulldogs were outgained 528-140 but were never behind the number. Talented QB Blake Baker has the weapons at WR & TE to challenge the Baylor secondary. LT is off next wk, while Baylor begins Big 12 play with a visit from Colorado.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 3 over Mississippi St - SC is 7-1 SU/ATS in this series and the home team is 7-2 ATS. Gamecocks has only faced Kent St and Towson so far. Miss St is 2-0 SU/ATS after crushing ULM in week 1 then LW they handled Minnesota on the road 38-13 with a 479-292 yd edge. QB Kamario Taylor has matched his hype, with a 7-0 ratio and hitting 68% completions along with 145 rush. Jayden Sellers has a 3-1 ratio this year but his supporting cast hasn't been helped him with drops and mistakes last week. Bulldogs are 6-3 as an AD and are getting over a fg. Miss St looks too good to go against right now.

FAU by 10 over Fiu - FAU covered 7 straight in the Shula Bowl, winning by 30.2 ppg between '17-'24 but LY FIU was -2' and won 38-28. The Over has hit in 8 of the last 9 mtgs and the favorite has covered 6 straight. Going back to LY FIU has covered 6 straight and we've won a 4★ LPS and an underdog POW already on the Panthers. Caden Veltkamp threw for 386 yds and 5 td's LW in FAU's 38-30 win over Navy (+4). The Owls led that game 38-7 late 3Q. FAU was 3-0 ATS as a HF in Kittley's first year. With both teams coming in off an upset, we prefer the home team with revenge in mind, Owls by 10.

APPALACHIAN ST by 28 over Charlotte - App St leads series 4-0 and dominated LY, 34-11, with a 368-yd edge. Mountaineers 6-0 SU & ATS vs American. In Wk 2, AppSt went into ECU as a 7pt dog and won 27-24. The offense is already vastly improved with Purdue transfer QB Malachi Singleton (81%, 3-0 ratio) and a corps of proven RB's. Charlotte is out of the gate slowly in HC Tim Albin's 2nd yr. 49ers are 0-2 SU & 1-1 ATS, with losses to the Citadel as a 20pt fav and Ole Miss last Saturday, 41-9. The offense is showing promise with the trio of QB Cole Gonzales, RB Khamani Alexander (AppSt transfer) and WR Jaylen Hampton. App St remains hot at home and easily disposes of a Charlotte team in danger of ranking among the FBS' weakest in '26.

Marshall by 7 over MISSOURI ST - Marshall is out for revenge for LY's 21-20 loss. That was MSU's first win as a member of the FBS. Casey Woods got his first win as HC LW, beating Lindenwood 48-14, finishing with a 584-223 yd edge. Skyler Locklear hit 17-20 for 258 yds. Marshall is 0-2 ATS and has yet to be impressive. They were blown out by Penn St in the opener then last week only beat Middle Tenn 28-26. QB Carlos Del Rio-Wilson hit 7 of 8 passes and a td but was injured and Marshall played 2 backups. Del Rio-Wilson is ? this week but the line is only -3' and we are giving Marshall one more chance to look like the team we expected.

UCF by 17 over Georgia St - Since '16, UCF is 24-16 ATS in non-conf games. As a DD fav, Knights 10-11-1 since '21 but 9-2 ATS when laying 20+ (1-9-1 laying between 10-19). GS 6-9 ATS last 5 yrs as a DD dog. After pounding Bethune-Cookman in the opener, 73-6, UCF fell last week at Pitt, 12-7, as a 7pt dog. It's Yr 2 in HC Scott Frost's return and the offense is still gelling (206 yds & just 20 rushing vs Pitt). Plus, new QB Alonza Barnett will miss multiple weeks with an injury and will be replaced by Keyone Jenkins. GS also opened with an FCS rout, beating NC A&T (+28), 59-10, before earning a big road win at Kennesaw St (-7), 31-17. They never trailed and finished +151 yds. Panthers 4-7-1 ATS as an AD under 3rd yr HC Dell McGee.

JACKSONVILLE ST by 7 over Georgia Southern - Georgia Southern (-3) won last yr at home, 41-34. Eagles fell behind late 3Q but scored final 10 pts to win. It was their 6th straight win in the series. GS 1-1 SU & 2-0 ATS in HC Clay Helton's 5th ssn. They beat Charleston Southern, 31-0, in Wk 1 as a 26pt fav and lost last wk at Clemson, 22-7, getting 20' pts. The offense has stalled so far but the D is playing well (kept Clemson out of EZ final 51 mins). Jax St is 1-2 SU & ATS. They lost both road gms at North Dakota St and Ohio, beating Eastern Kentucky, 49-7, in Wk 2 as a 20pt fav. They outgained the Bobcats 447-262 but fell short in OT. Gamecocks have the better QB in Caden Creel and are 15-5 ATS L/3 yrs at home while Helton is 11-21 ATS on the road.

Nevada by 3 over MIDDLE TENNESSEE - Middle was a 9' pt road dog LY and upset Nevada 14-13 which was 1 of MT's 3 wins. The Blue Raiders gave Marshall a run for their money last week, only losing 28-26. Their opener against Murray St was a 38-14 win and the game ended after 3 quarters due to weather. MT has 0 sacks in 2 games and Nevada has given up 0 sacks in their 2 games. The Wolfpack smoked WKU in their opener 49-14. Last week they had a 349-330 yd edge vs FCS National Champs Montana St but was also -4 TO's and lost 20-7. QB Carter Jones was hurt vs WKU and missed LW's game. This is Nevada's home opener and they haven't been an AF since '22. MT is a live dog with Gagliano at QB so we like the Blue Raiders to cover.

Ohio by 3 over SOUTH ALABAMA - In only prior mtg in '24, Ohio (+2) never trailed in 27-20 home win. Bobcats are one of the steadiest G6 tms, winning 40 gms over L/4 ssn! They're 1-1 SU & ATS in HC John Hauser's first yr. Ohio (+24) lost the opener at Nebraska, 49-21, but this was a 7pt gm in 4Q before Huskers scored 21 unanswered in final 9:10. Bobcats were -220 yds and allowed 523 yds. In last wk's home opener with Jax St, they rallied in 4Q and won in OT, 29-27, despite being -185 yds. USA is 1-1 (2-0 ATS), beating SELA, 39-14, as a 13'pt fav before suffering a crushing 28-24 loss at Tulane (-9). They were +12 fd's and are getting solid play from QB Bishop Davenport. Bobcats 21-9 ATS as a SD dog and will win another close one this Saturday.

Western Michigan by 13 over RICE - In their only prior mtg Rice (-3) won '08 Texas Bowl 48-13. Rice runs a run heavy option offense which eats up clock. The Owls (-22) only led FCS Houston Christian 17-3 HT & into 4Q before scoring 14 unanswered in 4Q for the front door cover. LW Rice (+45) trailed Notre Dame 42-0 HT & 52-0 into a scoreless 4Q being outgained 478-128. Western Michigan (+27) Beat lost to Michigan on an extra play Hail Mary 13-12. LW after some hangover from the loss, the Broncos (-27) led just 21-0 HT but 42-7 into 4Q & 49-7 before allowing a 75 yd td drive (almost 4 min) w/15 left. After the "loss" to Mich, WM HC said "don't feel bad for us, feel bad for our opponents the rest of the season". While the heat in Texas LW affected some game the Broncos opened as less than a 10 pt AF, so we look for them to get the cover here.

AUBURN by 3 over Florida - These two teams and coaches have familiarity despite not playing since '19. Last year Alex Goleish took his USF team to The Swamp and upset the Gators 18-16 (+18). Florida HC Jon Sumrall was HC at Tulane when his team beat Goleish's USF 45-10. Florida has been more impressive, with blowout wins over FAU and Campbell, averaging 569 ypg. RB Jadan Baugh averages 10.6 ypc! Auburn has played the tougher sked. They beat Baylor by an inch in the opener, then put up 610 yards vs SMiss in a 43-8 win. The Tigers are 0-2 ATS while Florida is 2-0 ATS. Florida's secondary is their biggest weakness. They allowed 276 passing vs FAU and Auburn's Byrum Brown will put pressure on their secondary, plus he can use his legs. We like the matchup for Auburn here and will take the team with the better defense at home by a fg.

UConn by 7 over SOUTHERN MISS - First Mtg. Both teams have new HC's and are 2 of the lease experienced teams (SMiss #136, UConn #138). UConn last mtg with SBC tm was in '24, when UConn beat Georgia St 34-27 but failed to cover as a 7 pt HF. In their opener UConn (-21) under new HC Jason Candle (11 yr HC Toledo) took no prisoners leading 35-0 HT & 56-0 4Q over FCS Lafayette before allowing a garbage td with :44 left. LW Huskies (+11) lost 38-14 to Maryland. Twice in 4Q Huskies were SOD in their own territory but a 15 yd fl (punt) & a missed 37 yd fg kept MD from scoring more. In their opener the Golden Eagles (-18) blew out Alcorn St 49-3. LW S Miss (+33) trailed 27-8 HT & 43-8 into a scoreless 4Q that only had 3 full drives with Auburn with Florida on deck ending a 6:14 drive at the USM 9 as time expired. UConn does have the edge on both Off (#112-#129) & Def (#109-#137) and should come away with win here **NORTHWESTERN by 3 over Colorado** - First mtg since '78. Last 5 Big Ten road trips, Colorado 1-4 SU & 2-3 ATS. Northwestern is coming off an unusually early bye and a Week 1 win over South Dakota St (+12), 34-18. The offense had 497 yds but the D allowed 432 yds and was -8 fd's. Colorado is 2-0 SU & 1-1 ATS with a quality opening win at GT, 14-13, on a Juju Lewis led drive late 4Q. Buffs played really well at the line of scrimmage (allowed 51 rush yds, 1.7 ypc) which was a concern in the offseason. Colorado used last wk's visit from Weber St to fine tune the passing game (398 yds, 4 td's) in a 52-21 win. Rested and with an extra week to prepare, the Wildcats win a close one and prevent Colorado from starting 2-0 outside Boulder.

BYU by 10 over COLORADO ST - Longtime Mountain West rivals mtg for 1st time s/'10. Last 7, BYU 7-0 SU & 5-2 ATS. This is Colorado St HC Jim Mora 1st big test here. His Rams are off to a 2-0 SU & ATS start. They impressed Wk 1, allowing just 273 yds in 35-13 win over rival Wyoming (+3). Last wk, the Rams used a visit from Southern Utah to open up the offense in a 58-24 rout. New QB Hauss Hejny has already accounted for 10 td's with a 9-1 passing ratio. BYU also 2-0 SU & ATS with wins over Utah Tech and Arizona. In the key Big 12 showdown with the Cats, they trailed at HT but finished strong for a 28-17 win. Fort Collins is forced up for this game and the Rams haven't been this confident in years so they'll keep it closer than the Vegas number.

OLE MISS by 3 over Lsu - There will be no more electric and volatile atmosphere in college football this week. Lane Kiffin returns to Ole Miss to face his former team after leaving them before their first trip to the playoffs. Both teams enter 2-0 though Ole Miss is 0-2 ATS. LSU only led LA Tech 10-7 at half last week despite not giving up a first down and LT's td was a 100 yd Pick-6. Ole Miss has the edge on offense with Trinidad Chambliss who takes care of the ball much better than Leavitt who has thrown 4 int's already. LSU's defense might be the best in the country as they've allowed just 16 FD's and already have 11 sacks. The home edge will be the tipping point here as Ole Miss has won 23 of their last 24 at home and have covered 4 straight as home dogs. Rebels by a fg!

NOTRE DAME by 31 over Michigan St - Notre Dame is 4-1 SU & 3-2 ATS in series s/'11 but the last mtg was in 2017 with both teams unranked, ND (-3) won 38-15. The Irish after being the first team out of the playoffs LY are following a creed of "Leave no Doubt" This year. In their opener the Irish (-21) only led Wisconsin 13-10 HT before pulling away for a 41-13 win. LW ND (-45) dominated Rice leading 42-0 HT with a 240-52 yd edge and after getting up 52-0 in 3Q cruised through a scoreless 4Q with backups getting plenty of time. Under new HC Pat Fitzgerald the Spartans (-10) trailed Toledo 20-19 in 4Q before scoring 10 unanswered incl a 51 yd fg w/1:55 left. LW vs an instate MAC foe Mich St (-17) only led Eastern Michigan 14-7 HT before pulling away in 2H for a 35-7 win. This of course is a big step up for the Spartans from a pair of MAC teams as ND has huge edges on both Off (#7-#64) and Def (#1-#36). Still with the line opening at over 4 td's, we think the Irish will cover but this Mich St team could score late to keep it interesting

TENNESSEE by 42 over Kennesaw St - Vols are off an impressive 45-24 win at GTech. The Vols ran for 299 yards including 147 by DeSean Bishop. QB Faizon Brandon has 0 int's in his first two starts as a true frosh. KSU was upset last week as 8 pt home chalk, losing to Georgia St 31-17. KSU was outgained 483-332 and allowed 253 pass and 230 rush. Vols have Texas on deck but Heupel is known for running the score up, allowing his backups to score late td's. Vols are 8-4 ATS laying over 30 pts since '22. KSU was +35 against Indiana and lost 56-9 last year. Vols backups will score a late td and get the cover.

TCU by 28 over Arkansas St - Ark St 2-11 all-time vs Big 12 foes and 1-3 ATS last 4. TCU spent the last 2 wks recovering from Wk 0 loss to UNC in Ireland, 15-10, as an 8 pt fav. The offense produced just 281 yds and 2.7 ypc vs the Heels so the bye and last wk vs Grambling was spent tweaking the offense (676 yds, 4 Jaden Craig td passes). Frogs are 1-4 ATS last 5 times they were laying 20+ points. Arkansas St has split its 1st 2 gms, losing to Memphis (-11), 42-24, before beating West Georgia, 52-7 as a 31 pt fav. Against Memphis, Red Wolves were outgained 523-434 and only trailed by 4 late 3Q, but the offense was done in by 4 Trey Owens INT's (13-17-135-2-0 last wk). This is another rough spot for Owens against a TCU team ready to build momentum.

TEXAS by 24 over Utsa - Texas is 2-0 SU/ATS vs UTSA. They won the last meeting 56-7 in '24 (-35). The whole world is crowning Texas after they rallied from down 23-3 4Q to beat Ohio St 24-23. UTSA is 2-0 SU/ATS after beating UTRGV and Texas St 31-26 though they were outgained 481-398 and were +3 TO's. Texas beat that same Texas St team 59-7 with a 516-349 yd edge so clearly we will like Texas given the comparative score? Not the case here, that was Texas' opener and despite Ohio St on deck they were fired up, and they gave up 225 first half yards in that game. Now the Longhorns are off a massive come-from-behind win which was fortunate considering Ohio St missed a game clinching fg prior to Texas' final td drive. Texas has Tennessee on deck so this is a flat spot sandwich game and UTSA has the offense to keep it closer than expected.

LOUISIANA by 17 over Uab - Louisiana has won 3 str SU & ATS in series ('02,'20,'23). In last mtg in '23, Cajuns (+2) scored first 27 pts in 41-21 win. L/4 yrs, UAB 8-16-1 ATS on the road but did open '26 by losing at Illinois, 42-23, as a 27 pt dog. Blazers were actually +81 yds, ran for 194 yds and were down just 1 prior to a Hail Mary before HT. In last wk's home opener with ULM, UAB (-9) won 26-20. They outgained Wahawks 381-257. Blazers 2-13-1 ATS last 4 yrs coming off SU win. Louisiana 1-1 SU & 2-0 ATS, beating Lamar (+19), 38-7, before losing to USC, 49-30, in the Coliseum as a 30 pt dog. They have 358 yds and never fell behind the number. QJ Lunch Winfield is playing well and they have the homegrown roster to roll by more than 2 td's this wk at home.

James Madison by 5 over SAN DIEGO ST - This is JMU's first-ever gm in California and longest trip of the yr. Dukes 2-0 SU & ATS in new HC Billy Napier's debut. They escaped Liberty (+6) Wk 1, 20-13, getting outgained by 30 yds but outrushing the Flames, 173-91. Last wk, they blasted Wagner, 87-3, with 588 yds of balanced offense. JMU has covered 4 straight as a road dog and Napier was 14-9-1 in that spot at Louisiana & Florida. San Diego St has split its 1st 2 gms. After beating Portland St, 53-20, as a 40 pt fav, the Aztecs lost last wk against UCLA, 28-10, as a 13 pt dog. The rebuilt D is not as feisty as LY and QB Jayden Denegal remains inconsistent (6-17-45-1-1 vs Bruins). Even with QB JC Evans out JMU will outrush the Aztecs for a mild road upset.

ARIZONA by 38 over Northern Illinois - Arizona is coming off emotional Big 12 loss at BYU. However, they played well and led at HT. Cats are 1-1 SU & 0-2 ATS, beating N Arizona (+31), 35-7, in a gm that was more lopsided than the score indicated. Noah Fifita is one of the FBS' top QB's and the rebuilt D is playing very well so far. NIU is turning the page this yr. New league, Mountain West, new HC, Rob Harley, and an entirely new roster. Huskies are 0-2 SU & ATS. In their first gm, Huskies (+31) lost at Iowa, 40-0, and were outgained 507-120. Last wk against FCS Illinois St (-3), they lost 28-24. This is a mismatch on both sides of the ball and NIU will struggle to score. Fifita has backups who'll keep the scoring going once the game is out of reach.

North Dakota St by 35 over SAC ST - The two FBS additions play each other. NDSU won the only prior meeting in 1988 D2 playoffs. NDSU has ben impressive in wins over Jax St, Fordham and Air Force. The Bison are only allowing 230 ypg and they allow just 104 rush ypg (29). QB Nathan Hayes is hitting 70% with a 6-2 ratio. Sac St wasn't ready for the move up to the FBS. They were outgained 260-34 in the 1H vs EMich and LW they lost 49-3 (+17) at Fresno St. They are allowing 71% completions and LW gave up 349 pass yds. QB Carson Conklin has missed the last two games. NDSU won 10 FCS National Titles while Sac St never got past the 2nd round of the FCS playoffs. Clearly NDSU is the superior program and laying just under 4 td's isn't too much.

UCLA by 17 over Purdue - Last met in 1980, now Big 10 foes. Bob Chesney has things turning around quickly for UCLA. They are 2-0 with wins over Cal and San Diego St. The Bruins have scored 6 of their 10 td's in the 4Q of their two games. RB Wayne Knight already has 6 td's while Nico lamaleava has yet to throw a td pass. Purdue nearly upset Wake Forest LW, losing 38-36 in OT (+3). QB Ryan Browne has thrown for 646 yds already with a 4-0 ratio and is hitting 77%. This is Purdue's road opener though and they've lost 15 straight road games (5-10 ATS). Bruins don't have much of a home field edge but they do have a big edge on defense and it's a long travel for Purdue and this game won't end until around 2 AM ET.

4★ Pittsburgh by 7 over NEW ENGLAND — Three 4th quarter INTs turned NE's 13-10 loss at SEA, an otherwise competitive defensive game, into a damaging opener for QB Drake Maye (178 pass yds, TD, 3 INT). The extended prep cannot replace WRA.J. Brown, now on IR, and RB TreVeyon Henderson remains questionable after NE managed just 277 yds and 10 pts in wk1. PIT allowed only 238 yds and 13 pts at ATL, while QB Aaron Rodgers (221 pass yds, TD) repeatedly attacked downfield; drops and tight no-call plays kept the final line from reflecting several potential explosives. Rodgers is 23-13 ATS as a dog of more than 3 and 16-8 ATS against opponents with extended prep since 2020, while the Rodgers-McCarthy pairing is 14-8-1 ATS in Weeks 1 and 2. NE's LY D ranked #4 in scoring (18.8 PPG), but PIT has the more reliable QB, a D led by LB T.J. Watt, and a far better chance to create chunk plays. Getting nearly 5 pts with PIT is a steal here.

3★ LA CHARGERS by 17 over Las Vegas — Three failed 4th-down tries were the difference in a game LAC had no business losing at ARI, and the drop from the preseason -9.5 range to -7 gives it the right wk2 bounce back spot. QB Justin Herbert (209 pass yds, TD, INT) never found rhythm, but RB Omarion Hampton (43 rush yds, TD) should see a much larger workload against an LV defense that was #25 in scoring D (25.4 PPG) LY. LV's 27-13 win over MIA came through 37 rushes, 5 sacks and ball control, not QB Kirk Cousins (160 pass yds, 3 TD, 2 INT) consistently pushing the ball downfield. RB Ashton Jeanty (102 rush yds, 45 rec yds, 3 TD) can keep LV competitive early, but it will be a different game if Herbert puts the Raiders in catch-up mode. LAC is 7-3 SU/ATS in the recent H2H, has won 4 straight meetings, and is 10-1-1 ATS in division games over the past 3 seasons. Teams off a double-digit wk1 loss at home or a neutral site are 28-9 ATS since 2015.

2★ Green Bay by 13 over NY JETS — GB's 39-22 loss at MIN was one of wk1's most misleading results. The Packers outgained MIN 419-239 and led 22-10 late in the 3rd before a failed 4th down, strip sack, INT and penalties fueled 29 unanswered pts. QB Jordan Love (387 pass yds, 2 TD) and WR Christian Watson (6-147, 2 TD) should find more room against a NYJ D that was #25 in YPG allowed (355.6) and #31 in scoring D (29.6 PPG) LY. NYJ's 23-10 win over TEN was clean, but it came against an offense that produced only 195 yds and 10 pts. GB is 14-7-1 ATS after allowing 30+ pts under Matt LaFleur, while wk2 road favorites off a loss against a wk1 winner have covered the prior 7 by 10.3 PPG.

Detroit @ BUFFALO — Thursday — The 1st regular season game at new Highmark Stadium brings 2 offenses that ranked top 5 in both YPG and scoring LY, and both opened 2026 with 30+ pts. QB Josh Allen (334 pass yds, 2 pass TD, 2 rush TD) led BUF to 409 yds on only 52 plays, while TE Dalton Kincaid (5-130) was the explosive piece DET could not match in its OT win. DET allowed 469 yds and has its LG, RT and C on the injury report for the short week, while QB Jared Goff (206 pass yds, 2 TD) never found the same consistency. RB Jahmyr Gibbs (156 rush yds, 2 TD) remains the major counterpunch. Campbell is 20-7 ATS as a dog of more than 3, but teams off OT who return Thursday or earlier are only 26% ATS. This is a major early measuring stick for both defenses.

Philadelphia by 10 over TENNESSEE — TEN gained only 195 yds and 10 pts in its opener, held the ball for 21:14, and allowed NYJ to run 39 times for 152 yds without recording a sack. QB Cam Ward (140 pass yds, TD) has little margin after PHI's D held WAS to 295 yds, even with QB Jalen Hurts (203 pass yds, 3 TD) and the offense managing only 318 yds. PHI's LY D ranked #13 in YPG allowed (314.2) and #5 in scoring D (19.1 PPG), while TEN's offense ranked #31 in YPG (259.6) and #30 in scoring (16.7 PPG). RB Saquon Barkley (83 rush yds) can keep the game manageable despite G Landon Dickerson going to IR. Hurts is 32-17-3 ATS after an outdoor win, including 9-1 in his last 10. PHI should pull away once TEN has to throw.

Minnesota by 4 over CHICAGO — CHI's 59 pts and 552 yds against CAR were enormous, but its D also surrendered 478 yds and 37 pts, creating a different problem against a division opponent. MIN has won 6 straight at Soldier Field and arrives with QB Carson Wentz (133 pass yds, 3 TD) expected to start after QB Kyle Murray's concussion. Wentz was efficient in relief, while WR Justin Jefferson (8-92, 2 TD) gives him a familiar high end target. CHI's QB Caleb Williams (269 pass yds, 2 TD) and RB D'Andre Swift (124 rush yds, 3 TD) were excellent, but teams that scored 40+ and won by 20+ in wk1 are 4-10 ATS since 2010. MIN was outgained 419-239 by GB yet won 39-22, so the defense has work to do. I expect CHI to cool off and MIN to stay in front.

Carolina by 6 over ATLANTA — CAR's 59-37 loss was ugly, but QB Bryce Young (361 pass yds, 3 TD) and WR Jalen Coker (8-138, 2 TD) generated 478 yds at 7.7 per play. ATL managed only 238 yds and 13 pts at PIT, with QB Cooper Rush (143 pass yds, 2 TD, 2 INT) taking 4 sacks while QB Tua Tagovailoa remains questionable. CAR's LY offense ranked #27 in YPG (295.6) and scoring (18.3 PPG), but its wk1 output was a major step forward. ATL's QB uncertainty and G Chris Lindstrom's concussion matter against a CAR front that got a sack from EDGE Princely Umanmielen. CAR is 7-3 ATS in the H2H over the past 5 seasons, while Dave Canales is 15-6 ATS after a loss. Young's offense should have enough answers after an ATL team still searching for one.

BALTIMORE by 7 over New Orleans — BAL opened with 506 yds and 41 pts against IND, as QB Lamar Jackson (324 pass yds, TD) and RB Derrick Henry (144 rush yds, 3 TD) turned every short field into a problem. NO deserves credit for rallying from 21-0 down at DET, where QB Tyler Shough (410 pass yds, 3 TD) and WR Chris Olave (10-182) piled up 469 yds and 30 pts. That OT road comeback now turns into another difficult road assignment, and NO's defense had no sacks or INTs against Jared Goff. BAL held IND to 251 yds, returns home, and could get DT Nnamdi Madubuike back. NO is a live dog after covering in wk1, but BAL's offense looks far more balanced and explosive. Jackson and Henry should be the difference late.

Cincinnati by 3 over HOUSTON — CIN won 33-27, but 3 1st half TB fumbles directly created 21 pts, making the final score a little kinder than QB Joe Burrow's 254 pass yds, TD and INT suggest. HOU lost at BUF but put up 381 yds and 31 pts, with QB C.J. Stroud (274 pass yds, 2 TD), RB David Montgomery (60 rush yds, 2 TD) and WR Nico Collins (7-75, TD) all productive. HOU's LY D was #1 in YPG allowed (277.2) and #2 in scoring D (17.4 PPG), though it could be without LB Henry To'o'o. CIN managed only 56 rush yds from RB Chase Brown last week, a concern against a defense built to limit balance. Burrow is 30-14 ATS on the road, while HOU is 9-2-1 Under at home after a loss under Stroud. CIN has the cleaner QB spot in a close road win.

TAMPA BAY by 17 over CLEVELAND — CLE's final numbers hid how bad the opener looked. QB Deshaun Watson was 11/17 for 100 yds and an INT at halftime with a 1.5 QBR before late production made his 205 yd, TD, INT line more presentable. TB lost 33-27 despite 4 fumbles, but QB Baker Mayfield completed 23/28 without an INT, and the game gives him a chance to respond against his former team. CLE was outgained 360-272, allowed 5 sacks and now loses RB Dylan Sampson to IR, while G Teven Jenkins remains questionable. The Browns' LY D ranked #4 in YPG allowed (283.6), but looked nothing like that LW. Expect Baker to take it to his former team that should force CLE into another long afternoon with a media storm around the QB position.

Jacksonville by 3 over DENVER — JAX had one of wk1's cleanest wins, beating CLE 34-10 with a 360-272 yd edge, no turnovers and 4 TD from QB Trevor Lawrence (245 pass yds, 4 TD). DEN got

outgained 392-176 at KC, produced only 9 1st downs and went 2/12 on 3rd down, leaving QB Bo Nix (131 pass yds, TD, INT) in a difficult early season spot. JAX's LY D ranked #11 in YPG allowed (303.6) and #8 in scoring D (19.8 PPG), and EDGE Josh Hines-Allen (1.5 sacks, FF, FR) gave it another disruptive performance. DEN's LY D was #2 in YPG allowed (278.2) and #3 in scoring D (18.3 PPG), so a bounce back is possible at home. Still, Lawrence and HC Liam Coen are both strong after wins, and JAX has the better offensive form.

Seattle by 10 over ARIZONA — SEA's defense remains the backbone of this team after it turned a 10-0 deficit into a 13-10 win with 3 4th quarter INTs. QB Drew Lock (187 pass yds, TD) gets the start with QB Sam Darnold out, but WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba (8-122, TD) gives him a reliable target and SEA's LY D ranked #1 in scoring (17.2 PPG) and #6 in YPG allowed (285.9). ARI deserves credit for outgaining LAC 393-268 and controlling the ball for 37:31, led by QB Jacoby Brissett (277 pass yds, TD) and TE Trey McBride (9-95, TD). SEA is 9-1 SU and 8-2 ATS in the last 10 H2H, while ARI is 0-4 ATS in its last 4 home games. SEA's defense should keep Lock out of a shootout and create separation.

SAN FRANCISCO by 20 over Miami — MIA is now making consecutive road trips from Las Vegas to San Francisco after gaining only 259 yds and 13 pts in the wk1 loss. QB Malik Willis (220 pass yds, 39 rush yds, rush TD) was under constant pressure as LV recorded 5 sacks, and the offense now meets an SF defense that allowed only 290 yds and 7 pts in Melbourne. QB Brock Purdy (205 pass yds, 3 TD) led SF's 379 yd performance, while RB Christian McCaffrey (68 rush yds) and WR Demarcus Robinson (2-50, TD) helped finish drives. SF had 10 days between games, though the Australia to Los Angeles return adds its own travel element. MIA's LY offense ranked #26 in YPG (300.7) and #25 in scoring (20.4 PPG). The 49ers' pressure and MIA's travel load make this a difficult matchup to keep close.

DALLAS by 13 over Washington — DAL has owned this H2H at 8-2 SU/ATS over the past 5 seasons and gets a WAS team opening with consecutive road division games. QB Dak Prescott (175 pass yds, 2 TD, INT) needs a much better response after DAL gained only 244 yds at NYG, but this is a favorable reset against a defense that ranked #32 in YPG allowed (384.0) LY. WAS gained only 295 yds at PHI, with QB Jayden Daniels (164 pass yds, 2 TD) unable to sustain much beyond the late rally. DAL's own D was #30 in YPG allowed (377.0) and #32 in scoring D (30.1 PPG) LY, and injuries to LB DeMarion Overhown and S Malik Hooker do matter. Still, WAS does not have the same ball control threat NYG used in wk1. Prescott should get the offense moving indoors and turn the historical edge into a big win.

Indianapolis @ KANSAS CITY — SNF — A 6-day turnaround after MNF adds a wrinkle for KC after it dominated DEN 31-10 with a 392-176 yd edge. RB Kenneth Walker III (173 rush yds, TD) gave KC the rushing threat it lacked LY, while the D allowed only 9 1st downs. IND absorbed a 506-251 yd loss at BAL, but RB Jonathan Taylor (98 rush yds, 2 TD) remains the piece capable of keeping it competitive. KC is 3-13 ATS after scoring 30+ since 2022, while wk2 favorites playing a 2nd straight home game are 2-12 ATS since 2017. IND's road bounce back spot is 26-6 ATS, so Taylor's early workload will determine whether this stays tight at Arrowhead.

NY Giants @ LA RAMS — MNF — The Melbourne return is the major backdrop after LAR had 11 days off but also a long Australia-to-Los Angeles trip and lost EDGE Myles Garrett to IR. QB Matthew Stafford (155 pass yds, INT) and the LY #1 YPG O (394.6) must rebound from a 27-7 loss in which SF outgained LAR 379-290. NYG arrives off a sharp 28-20 win at DAL, controlling the ball for 36:40 behind QB Jaxson Dart (230 pass yds, 3 TD), RB Cam Skattebo (81 rush yds, TD) and TE Isaiah Likely (8-78, 2 TD). John Harbaugh is 46-28-4 ATS as a road dog, and NYG gets a favorable number against a depleted LAR D. 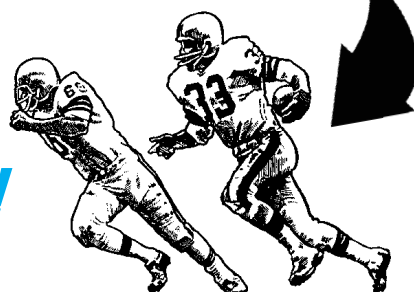
