4★ UTAH over Texas Tech - Red Raiders making first trip to Salt Lake City in a battle to determine the early frontrunner in the Big 12 title chase. Both teams are 3-0 SU & ATS, ranked and among the highest scoring tms in the country. But neither has been challenged so this is a critical early test with CFP implications. TT has cruised past Ark-Pine Bluff, Kent St and Oregon St by an avg score of 58-12. They endured a 2 1/2 hr delay LW to beat the Beavers (+24), 45-14. Behren Morton threw 4 td passes and they were +310 yds in the win. L/6 road openers, Tech 0-6 SU & ATS! Utah's 2 FBS wins are over UCLA, which just fired its HC, and 23'pt HD Wyoming. Utah has more offensive diversity with dual-threat QB Devon Dampier, and we like their overall physicality in this matchup. Kyle Whittingham and Utah are used to this stage. Joey McGuire and TT are not. We've already won twice with Utah as star-rated plays on these pages. Playing at Rice-Eccles (93-30 under Whittingham), we are riding Utah's ATS streak for our top newsletter play!

FORECAST: UTAH by 14

3★ WISCONSIN over Maryland - Maryland is 0-4 all-time in series losing by avg of 36-14. Last time here, Terps (+5) trailed 17-0 half, managed 189 yds, & scored TD w/57 left in a 23-10 loss. We cashed our 4H Power Sweep Play and LPS LW going against the Badgers in their trip to Bama, a 38-14 (+19) loss and they were outgd 454-209. Much better situation for Wisconsin here, hosting Maryland who is just 16-35 SU on the road the last 11 years (7-22 ATS AD since '19) and Locksley is 6-14 ATS as an AD here. QB Edwards could return this week to face his former team. Last week, Maryland blasted in-state foe FCS Towson (Locksley's alma mater), 44-17 (-28), led 34-0 at half. This is QB Washington's first career road start (62%, 6-1 this yr). Badgers are laying 9' and they've brought multiple 5★ winners in the past so we expect the Badgers to win by almost 3 td's!

FORECAST: WISCONSIN by 20

3★ North Carolina over UCF - First meeting. Since getting drubbed in their opener by TCU, NC has outscored their last two opponents 61-9 so clearly Bill Belichick's team is improving. UCF only beat Jax State 17-10 in the opener and crushed a poor NC A&T team 68-7. They are fresh off a bye this week. NC's tackling was atrocious in the opener but they've allowed just 235 ypg in their last 2. Much of the Tar Heels team didn't arrive until after spring so it's not surprising they had a poor opener. NC has a massive coaching edge with Belichick vs Scott Frost and they are nearly a touchdown underdog. We think NC wins this game outright as Belichick gets his first marquee win.

FORECAST: North Carolina by 6

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ OKLAHOMA over Auburn - 2nd SEC meeting. Last year Auburn had this game all but won. They were up 21-10 4Q. OK scored and Aub drove into OK territory but QB Thorne threw a pick-6 and OK won 27-21 (+1). Aub finished w/a 482-291 yd edge. That Sooners team was decimated with injuries at WR and OLine. QB Jackson Arnold faces his former team who he started 9 games for last year. He has led the Tigers to a 3-0 start including a win over Baylor. He is hitting 70% w/a 4-0 ratio and is their #2 rusher with 192 (5.5). OK is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS and they have a win over Michigan. Last week they were -24 at Temple and won 42-3. Wash St transfer QB John Mateer has a 5-3 ratio. The Sooners D is allowing just 181 ypg and they are #7 in our pass D efficiency rankings (46%, 85 ypg). We give the Sooners the edge in all 3 phases, plus a coaching edge. OK is on a 10-3 ATS run as a HF and we won a 2★ on these pages going with OK over Michigan two weeks ago so it's back to Boomer Sooner this week.

FORECAST: OKLAHOMA by 17

2★ MIAMI, OH over UNLV - First Meeting. Both teams are off a bye. Miami has an FCS foe on deck while UNLV has another bye. While the RedHawks have not faced a MWC in the regular season since '12 but LY Miami (-2) beat Colorado St 43-17 in the Bowl. Rebels' first MAC foe since '16, losing their L/3 (1-2 ATS). New UNLV HC Dan Mullen is just 18-17-1 as an away favorite including a win at Sam Houston (38-21, -9) but that team has lost all 3 games TY by 17 pts. UNLV is 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS but only beat Idaho St (now 0-3) in the opener 38-31 which then lost to Southern Utah 46-24. The Rebels (+2) upset of P4 foe UCLA 30-23, which then lost to New Mexico 35-10 LW. Miami is 0-2 this year (1-1 ATS) vs two Big Ten teams. Miami (+17) only lost 17-0 to Wisc & only trailed Rutgers 24-17 mid-3Q before allowing L/21. While Miami's 12th year HC normally concentrates on MAC play, his team is on a 7-4 ATS run vs non-conf foe & no HC wants to start 0-3. This is also a noon KO, which is a 9 AM start for UNLV, so we will ride the HD here.

Rice is 2-1 SU/1-2 ATS, with an upset win over Louisiana in wk1. Last week they were -29' against Prairie View A&M. It was 38-10 and Rice allowed a garbage time td with 1:45 left. CLT's offense had put up just 14 points and 245 ypg in their F/2 games vs App St and NCar but Monmouth was a pure Over team and despite a slow start, CLT put up 42 points and 563 yards in a 7 point win. Rice is running the triple option this year and while CLT gave up 51 points last year to Navy, they did only allow 288 yards including 171 rush but were -5 TO's but they have a new DC. FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 19th

OKLAHOMA ST by 17 over Tulsa - Cowboys have won 10 straight in series and 23 in a row in Stillwater! However, they've failed to cover last 2 at home as a DD fav. OSU is coming off a bye (6-2 ATS L/8 on extra rest). Before break, they were dismantled by Oregon (-28), 69-3, and are 0-2 ATS. In the opener with UT Martin (+25'), Pokes won 27-7 but produced just 359 yds. Tulsa is rebuilding in HC Tre Lamb's first year. Hurricane is 1-2, beating Abilene Christian in the opener before losing SU & ATS to NM St and Navy. They were +85 yds vs the Aggies and led in 4Q but lost on td with 3:23 left. Lamb had QB Baylor Hayes at ETSU so there's a familiarity with the system. OSU is rested and the extra practice will help QB Zane Flores whose start against Oregon was the first of his career. Plus, HC Mike Gundy is in must-win territory after going 3-9 LY. LY we cashed our Sept 5★ GOM going against OSU. We think OSU will maintain its dominance on Tulsa with a comfortable win by more than 2 td's.

Iowa by 3 over RUTGERS - Hawkeyes have won all 4 meetings ('16,'19, '22, '23) by combined score of 93-17. Last time here in '22, Iowa was outgained 361-277, but scored two defensive TDs in a 27-10 win. Rutgers is 1-3 ATS all-time vs. Iowa. Scarlet Knights have scored 17 total pts in 4 meetings and have been shutout twice. Since joining B10 in '14, Rutgers is 2-9 SU (6-5 ATS) in conf home openers. Rutgers is just 3-11-1 ATS as a HD since Schiano returned and Iowa is 19-8-1 ATS as an AF the last 11 years. Last week, Iowa blew out UMass at home, 47-7 (-34') to improve to 2-1 SU, with HC Ferentz surpassing Woody Hayes for most all-time B10 wins! Last week, Rutgers rolled over FCS Norfolk St., 60-10 (-44') with a 563-220-yard edge, improving them to 3-0 SU. Early line has Iowa -2' - we think that sounds about right.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 13th

ARMY by 3 over North Texas - Army won this matchup 14-3 (-6) last year. NT was SOD at the Army 2, int'd at the Army 11 and int'd at the Army 2. NT is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS and were dominant last week, crushing Washington St 59-10 (-5'), cashing 3★ winners in both Power Sweep and our LPS!

COLLEGE MARQUEES!!!!!!

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Army suffered a surprising upset to Tarleton St in week 1 but responded with a win over Kansas St and now they are off a bye. Last year NT had the bye week to prep for the option. Army's Dewayne Coleman is the more explosive option QB. He was hurt in the opener and didn't play vs Kansas St but should be healthy this week. NT QB Drew Mestemaker is hitting 70% with a 9-0 ratio. Army is #40 in our pass D efficiency rankings (56%, 2-1). The situation favors Army here but we like this NT team so it's a small lean on the home team.

TCU by 3 over SMU - 104th meeting for the Iron Skillet between local DFW rivals. TCU wants revenge this weekend. HC Sonny Dykes, who coached at SMU from '18-21, was tossed from LY's 66-42 loss in Dallas. Frogs were actually +105 yds in the blowout but allowed 3 non-off td's (FR/PR/pick6). TCU is off to a 2-0 start. They crushed UNC (+3) in the opener, 48-14, but failed to cover LW vs Abilene Christian. Frogs (-39) led 28-0 at HT but tapped the brakes in 2H and allowed 21 pts & 453 yds in 42-21 win. SMU is 2-1 SU but 0-3 ATS, all as a favorite. The Mustangs rebounded from a crushing OT loss to Baylor by beating Missouri St (+28) this past weekend, 28-10. They fell behind 10-0 and only led 14-10 at HT before pulling away for a 28-10 win. TCU is off to the stronger start, and QB Josh Hoover will thrive against a secondary that allowed 440 yds in the Baylor loss. Dykes gets payback for LY in a high-scoring gm decided by just a FG.

Louisiana by 7 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Both have their conference opener on deck. Fourth meeting, Louisiana has won & covered last 2. Last met in '22, Cajuns (-11) trailed 21-14 at home in 3Q but scored final 35 pts finishing +5 TO's. LA is 7-1 SU but just 4-4 ATS vs MAC. Eagles are just 3-6 SU & 4-5 ATS vs SBC including this year's opener when EM (+14) lost 52-27 at Texas St being out gained 606-391. Despite being 0-3 SU & ATS EM QB Noah Kim is having a solid season hitting 256 ypg (63%) with a 4-1 ratio including 25-42-330-1-1 LW vs Kentucky. Unfortunately the Eagles' defense has struggled allowing 526 ypg including 292 ypg rush & 6.7 ypc. That includes 28 pts & 479 yds to FCS Long Island that in their other 2 gms (Florida & Sacred Heart) had a combined 21 pts & 294 yds. That is good news for the Cajuns offense that is avg 194 ypg rush & 5.9 ypc (5.3 vs Missouri). While EM is usually a great dog, they were just 1-2 SU & ATS as under a TD dog LY. With the Cajuns as under a FG favorite, we look for them to run past the Eagles.

GEORGIA TECH by 27 over Temple - These two last met when GT was in their first season under Geoff Collins and went away from the triple option. Temple was actually -8' and won 24-2. Much different circumstances here though as GT is #18 and off an upset win over Clemson. The Jackets are 3-0 SU/ATS this year. Temple won their first two games by 32 & 48 points but were no match for OK last week in a 42-3 loss where they were outgained 515-104. Owls QB Evan Simon has a 9-0 ratio but only hit 13-25 for 75 yards last week. We doubt Haynes King does much running this week so expect a big game from RB Jamal Haynes (183, 4.9). Temple allowed 228 (5.4) rush last week vs the Sooners. This isn't the ideal situation for GT but they have covered 3 straight as favs of -20 or more so GT gets a small lean.

BYU by 7 over EAST CAROLINA - BYU is 0-3 ATS all-time vs ECU and lost L/2 in '17 and '22 outright as the fav. Cougars are coming out of a bye (2-0 SU & 1-1 ATS LY off bye wk). They're 2-0 SU & ATS in '25 and allowed 3 combined pts to Portland St and Stanford. Under HC Kalani Sitake, BYU has won 7 straight road openers (7-0 ATS incl 4 outright upsets!). The early bye will help the development of true frosh QB Bear Bachmeier. ECU is 2-1 and playing well. Pirates' only loss was by 7 to NC St and they've covered all 3. They just blanked Coastal Carolina (+7) 38-0 on the road, and the D hasn't allowed a td in 9 quarters. Pirates had 5 sacks and outgained the Chants 497-239. BYU is the better and more physical tm. But Greenville will be rocking, and a defense gaining in confidence now faces a QB with just 2 gms of experience. We expect BYU to win another road opener but it'll be close, low-scoring and tight for all 4 quarters.

MIAMI (FL) by 7 over Florida - Miami is 3-0 ATS in this series including a 41-17 (-2') win in last year's opener. Florida started 1-2 last year and Napier was on the hot seat but won their next two over Miss St and UCF. Once again Napier is on the hot seat after a 1-2 start including a loss to USF who Miami just beat 49-12 (-17'). Canes are 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS and are +202 ypg. Florida actually outgained LSU 366-316 last week, holding the Tigers to 96 rush yards on 25 carries but QB Lagway threw 5 int's and they lost 20-10 (+7). Gators are clearly the deperate team here and Napier is 14-7-1 ATS as a road dog. They may have upset LSU if it wasn't for the interceptions and we expect Lagway to take better care of the ball this week so Florida keeps it closer.

LOUISVILLE by 24 over Bowling Green - 1st meeting. BG is 7-1-1 ATS vs Power-4 teams and they've covered their last 5 vs Power4 foes including upset wins over Georgia Tech in '23 and Minnesota in '21. Last year they only lost 34-27 at #8 Penn St and 26-20 at #25 Texas A&M. L'ville is 2-0 and fresh off a bye but two weeks ago trailed James Madison 14-6 3Q and they were held to 264 yards but got a fumble return td and won 28-14 (-14'). BG just pulled an upset over Liberty last week, winning 23-13 though they were outgained 346-304 and were +4 TO's. QB Drew Pyne is hitting 67% w/a 2-0 ratio. BG true frosh LB Dorian Pringle is their #1 tk'l'r and has 6 ffl's but was injured and is a ? this week. L'ville is 9-4 as a HF under Brohm but they are laying over 3 td's and have their ACC opener on deck. Eddie George has this team competing and should stay within the line.

CLEMSON by 24 over Syracuse - Syracuse was a thorn in Clemson's side when Dino Babers was HC. Clemson has won the last 6 meetings but Syracuse covered four of those. This is the first meeting between HC's Fran Brown and Dabo Swinney. Clemson is coming off their 2nd loss of the season already after GTech kicked a 55 yd GW fg as time expired last week. Clemson lost their opener to LSU as well and they are 0-3 ATS this year. Cuse went 10-3 in HC Brown's first year but only had 8 starters back in a rebuilding year. They were outgained 493-377 and lost by 19 to Tennessee in the opener and needed OT to beat UConn. Last week they were -38' and beat FCS Colgate 66-24 but did allow 408 yards including 301 passing. Cade Klubnik has been playing w/o their top WR Antonio Williams and LT Tristan Leigh (check status). Clemson still has a shot at the ACC Title game, we expect them to refocus and win by over 3 td's. We cashed a 5★ Sept GOM back in '18 on Clemson when they crushed GTech 49-21 (-16) and the Tigers could be in the mix again.

INDIANA by 7 over Illinois - Illinois leads series 46-25-2, but Indiana is 4-1 SU & 5-0 ATS last 5 meetings. Last time out in '23, Indiana (+4) sent gm to OT with :28 left, but lost, 48-45, as Illini QB Paddock threw for 507 & 4 TDs off the bench. Hoosiers have covered last 5 vs. Illinois, and won last 2 outright at home. In '22 at home, IU (-1) scored game-winning TD with :23 left. Last 2 games were decided by 3 pts. Hoosiers on a 12-6 ATS run vs B10. Indiana is 9-1 ATS as a HF under Curt Cignetti, 5-0 SU & 4-1 ATS in home B10 games. Last week, Indiana blasted in-state rival FCS Indiana St, 73-0 (-46'), behind a 6-TD day from QB Fernando Mendoza (5 pass, 1 rush). Bret Bielsma is 12-4 ATS as an AD with Illinois and has a veteran team. Last week, the Illini blanked Western Michigan, 38-0 (-27') behind a huge 2nd half. This is the first time since 1950 that both teams are ranked coming into this game. Cignetti has Indiana back to dominating foes and we can't go against the Hoosiers at home.

NC State by 3 over DUKE - Duke has won 4 of the last 5 meetings SU & ATS. NCSt was -3 last year and were coming off 2 straight wins. Duke got a safety, fg and went 7/3 td, led 12-0. NCSt settled for 4 fg's, trailed 26-12 & lost 29-19. Duke has lost their last two games despite putting up 479 ypg. QB Mensah has thrown for 1,036 (67%) w/an 8-2 ratio. Last week they were +1 and trailed 34-16 at Tulane then scored 11 points in the last 3 minutes for a misleading 7 point loss. NCSt is 3-0 with two close wins and last week they were down 14-0 just 8 minutes in and down 24-17 at half. The 'Pack dominated the 2H and won 34-24 (-7). RB Hollywood Smothers leads with 380 (6.0) and their offense has put up the most yards that all 3 opponents have allowed. Duke is 0-3 ATS this season and 1-4 as a HF under Diaz. We think NCSt is the better team and moves to 4-0 with a win.

FLORIDA ST by 45 over Kent St - FSU is 5-0 all-time vs MAC with L/2 being wins over Northern Illinois in the '18 & '13 Orange Bowls covering both. Kent St is 1-10 vs ACC foes losing L/10. They are jus 3-6 ATS L/9 including a 55-24 loss at Pitt LY (+24). The Seminoles have already equalled LY's win total (2) including shocking #8 Alabama in the season opener 31-17 (+14). They then showed no mercy vs East Texas A&M winning 77-3 (-46). The Flashes opened with a non-covering win over an FCS foe but once again have a killer non-conf schedule. They travel to Oklahoma next after a bye after covering 2 wks ago vs Texas Tech +48' (lost 62-14 after 4Q TT td). LW they almost shocked Buffalo as a23' pt HD only losing 31-28. While we don't expect another upset bid here, FSU has their conference opener at Virginia on Friday, which could have them calling off the dogs a little early & KS has shown some life despite their tough schedule.

Toledo by 17 over WESTERN MICHIGAN - Last year was the first time since 1949 that teams did not play. In '23 WM (+21) led 31-28 early 4Q, but lost 49-21. Home team is 7-1 SU & 6-2 ATS. Broncos are 0-3 SU but 2-1 ATS and led North Texas 27-17 4Q before falling 33-30 in OT (+10). The Rockets are 2-1 SU & 3-0 ATS and in their 24-16 loss (+10) at Kentucky finished with a 329-304 yd edge (17-17 FD). LW Toledo (-33) only led Morgan St 3-0 into 2Q before scoring 43 pts, the most in a single quarter by the Rockets in 109 yr history. While the Broncos return just 7 starters from LY's 6-7 team, Toledo is the 25th most experienced team returning 13 starters LY's 8-5 team. With that experience and the talent edge we look for Toledo to take care of business here.

BUFFALO by 10 over Troy - First-ever regular season meeting (Troy won 2018 bowl, 42-32). Buffalo is 2-1SU and ATS. Bulls lost the opener at Minnesota (-17'), 23-10, before handling overmatched St Francis (+38), 45-6. However, in LW's MAC opener at Kent St, Buffalo (-22') needed a td with 1:03 left to avoid the upset. Ta'Quan Roberson threw 3 td passes and the offense had its best gm, but the veteran D allowed 423 yds to a Kent offense that was struggling entering Week 3. Troy is 1-2 SU and ATS, with the only win over Nicholls. Since taking a 16-0 lead on Clemson in Week 2, Trojans have been outscored 55-7. LW against Memphis, they knotted the Tigers at 7 but allowed the final 21 pts. Troy was outgained 430-112 and got dominated at the point of attack. Buffalo is back home and ready to make amends on defense. Neither team will do much offensively, and Troy is without injured QB Goose Crowder (backup Tucker Kilcrease was 10-29-65-0-1 in his place last wk). Bulls will clamp down on Troy and win by double-digits.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 21 over Coastal Carolina - First meeting since 2021. Coastal Carolina (-15) needed a 4Q rally to win 27-21 in OT. South Alabama is 1-2 but they covered their L/2 vs Tulane and Auburn and are battle-tested for the start of SBC play. Jags (+13) nearly upset the visiting Green Wave and only lost 31-15 at Jordan-Hare as a 24pt dog. USA had more fd's than Auburn and was just -27 yds. The Chanticleers are off to a brutal start for 3rd yr HC Tim Beck. They're 0-3 ATS and have been outscored 86-7 in 2 gms vs FBS opp. CCU was just a 7' dog LW vs East Carolina, but got bounced 38-0 for their first shutout loss since joining the FBS in 2017. The QB room is in disarray and Beck is beginning to feel the heat. After facing 2 quality opponents as a dog, South Alabama is eager to flex its muscles on both sides of the ball. We expect the Jags to play their most complete game of the month and bounce the fading Chants by 3 td's.

TENNESSEE by 42 over Uab - Tennessee is 5-0 all-time but only 2-3 ATS vs UAB. The last meeting was in 2019 and the Vols were -12' and won 30-7. Josh Heupel has a tough task getting his team up for this game after nearly ending an 8 game series losing streak to Georgia. They put up 38 points/496 yards in regulation but missed a GW fg and lost in OT. UAB is 2-1 SU/1-2 ATS and their only cover was as an away dog vs Navy. UAB allowed Akron (0 pts F/2 gms) to put up 28 points and 441 yards last week but won 31-28. QB Jalen Kirtina has hit 70% with a 6-3 ratio and faces a Tennessee D that is likely missing their top two CB's again. UAB's D is allowing 36 ppg/473 ypg. Even if the Vols get a big lead, Heupel let's his backups run the offense and score. They put up 72 points two weeks ago against ETSU, scoring their final td with 3:55 left. UAB will get on the board a few times but the Vols 9-4 ATS off a loss under Heupel and 8-1 ATS when laying 30+ points.

UTSA by 6 over COLORADO ST - First mtg since home & home in '15 and '16 (UTSA 0-2 SU but 2-0 ATS). Roadrunners are 1-2 SU and 2-1 ATS. They lost the opener to Texas A&M (-23'), 42-24, before suffering a disappointing home 43-36 loss to Texas St as a 4pt favorite. The loss at Kyle Field was their 8th straight on the road dating back to 2023. They did rebound LW to topple FCS ranked Incarnate Word (+19'), 48-20. The offense was balanced with 4 Owen McCown td passes and 144 rushing yds from Robert Henry. Colorado St is coming out of its first bye, while UTSA will be off next wk. The Rams are 1-1 SU & ATS, losing and covering the opener with Washington and escaping Northern Colorado, 21-17, as a 35'pt favorite in Week 2. CSU had five costly turnovers and needed to score two 2H td's to climb back from a 17-7 deficit. They did outgain the Bears 371-223 in the narrow win. UTSA appears to have righted the ship with LW's win and have the better weapons in this one. We have them winning in Fort Collins by 6 in a lower-scoring gm.

COLORADO by 14 over Wyoming - These schools are separated by only 110 miles but last met in 2009 (Colorado won 24-0 as 7pt fav). This is a sandwich game for the Buffs between Big 12 tilts. They lost last Friday at Houston (-4'), 36-20, and host BYU next wk. Colorado was down just 16-14 at HT but Cougars scored first 17 pts of 2H and wound up +131 yds. Buffs fell to 0-2-1 ATS and the offense is struggling at only 5.3 ypp. Wyoming is playing b2b games against the Big 12. They lost to Utah (-23') LW in Laramie, 31-6, to suffer their first SU & ATS loss. Utes got the frontdoor cover on an 11yd td run with 1:11 left. Cowboys held Utah to its lowest scoring output of the month so far and they're #13 in my Pass Eff D rankings. Colorado's QB problems will continue this weekend in Boulder. Neither team is making chunk plays downfield so we expect a low-scoring gm. Colorado evens their record with a DD win, pulling away in the 2H for a 2 td win.

OREGON by 45 over Oregon St - 129th edition of the "Civil War." Beavers haven't won in Eugene since '07 (0-8 SU & 4-4 ATS since). Since '04, the Over is 16-5 & 8-2 at Outzen. OSU has scored 21 pts the last 2 meetings (lowest total since '92-'93). Last time here in '23, OSU (+14) lost, 31-7. Ducks have won last 2 & 14 of last 17 since '08. Last year in Corvallis, Ducks (-17') led 22-14 at half and Oregon St had a 218-217 yard edge. Oregon blew open a close game by scoring final 27 pts for 49-14 win and finished with 546-309 yd edge. OSU is 3-7 ATS as AD the last 5 years and Lanning is 13-7 ATS as a HF and 12-6 ATS as a 20+ favorite. Last week, OSU was blown out by Texas Tech, 45-14 (+23'). Oregon is in a B10 sandwich with a huge game vs Penn St on deck. Last week, Oregon defeated Northwestern 34-14 (-25') in its B10 opener. Early line has Oregon -35'. This should be another blowout win for the Ducks.

OLE MISS by 10 over Tulane - Last meeting was in '23. Tulane was w/o starting QB Pratt yet led 17-10 at half. Ole Miss was up 27-20 4Q and added a fg and a fumble return td in the final 2 minutes. Tulane is 3-0 with two wins over P4 teams (NW & Duke). Last week Tulane (-1') led Duke 34-16 4Q and allowed 10 points in the last 3 minutes. Ole Miss is 3-0 and are in an Arkansas/LSU sandwich. D2 transfer Trinidad Chambliss was impressive in relief of inj'd starter Austin Simmons. Chambliss went 21-29-353-1-0 and led the Rebels in rushing (15-62, 2 td's). Ole Miss allowed 526 yards including 305 passing and QB Taylon Greene had 115 rush. Tulane QB Retzlaff has topped 100 rush vs both NW and Duke. The Rebels could be looking ahead to LSU and Sumrall is 5-2 as an away dog so we have a small lean on the Green Wave.

KANSAS by 18 over West Virginia - West Virginia has won 9 of L/10 in series and the visitor is 8-2 ATS since 2014. The over has cashed in 5 straight and 7 of the L/8 mtgs. Mountaineers (-1) won LY, 32-28, despite trailing 28-17 late in the 4Q. While Kansas is coming off a bye wk, WVU is coming off an emotional OT win over Pitt in the "Backyard Bowl". Mountaineers (+7) were down 24-14 in the 4Q but scored 10pts in the final 5mins and the only OT pts for a 31-24 win. It was a complete turnaround after having just 250 yds a week earlier in a 17-10 loss at Ohio (+3'). Kansas entered the break 2-1 SU & 1-2 ATS. The 31-7 win over Fresno St looks much better now that the Bulldogs are 3-1. Jayhawks lone loss at rival Missouri, 42-31, came in a gm they led in the 4Q but were outgained 595-226. This is a situational spot that favors Kansas. Jayhawks are rested and back at their refurbished home where they're 2-0, while WVU is due for a letdown after upsetting its biggest rival. We have KU getting payback for last year's collapse in Morgantown and winning here by double-digits.

BAYLOR by 6 over Arizona St - If Texas Tech-Utah is this wk's Big 12 title bout, this one in Waco is the undercard. ASU is the defending league champ while Baylor believes it has the tm to dethrone them. Bears have bounced back from a Wk 1 loss to Auburn by winning 2 straight. They beat SMU (-3), 48-45, in a double OT thriller and then LW handled Samford (+42'), 42-7. They led 35-7 at HT and coasted to the final whistle. The offense is potent, led by QB Sawyer Robertson (10-2 ratio) and RB Bryson Washington (b2b 100yd gms). The Sun Devils have not been sharp so far. They're 1-2 ATS and lost their only road gm at Mississippi St as a 6' favorite. ASU did bounce back LW to hand Texas St (+16) their first loss, 34-15. However, they average just 6.1 ypp (10th in Big 12) and have yet to adjust to the loss of RB Cam Skattebo. In the QB matchup, we like Robertson over Sam Leavitt (5-3 ratio/played poorly at MSU). We expect Baylor to hold off ASU by 6.

USC by 24 over Michigan St - Teams have split last 8 meetings, but this is their 1st B10 meeting. MSU has won 3 straight, including '88 Rose Bowl & '90 Sun Bowl (last mtg). Spartans 0-3 at Coliseum (63, 72, '78). Last 10 road openers, MSU is 7-3 SU & 6-3-1 ATS. Trojans last hosted MSU in '78 (30-9 USC win). Last week, MSU defeated FCS Youngstown St, 41-24 (-23'), improving to 3-0. WR Marsh was injured and sat out the 2H, as were 2 OL and a RB. USC is 8-2 SU (5-5 ATS) last 10 conf home openers. Since '21, Trojans are 20-7 to the over at home. Lincoln Riley is 13-6 ATS as a HF with USC but, in his lone matchup with Jonathan Smith, only beat Oregon St on the road 17-15 (-5) in 2022. Smith is 16-9 ATS as an AD. Last week, USC defeated B10 foe Purdue, 33-17 (-20'), to improve to 3-0 despite a 3-hr weather delay and a +203-yd advantage. Early line has USC -17'. We expect USC by a touchdown more than that.

UCONN by 30 over Ball St - Huskies are just 5-5 SU & ATS their L/10 vs MAC. Ball St is 4-0 SU & 2-2 ATS in the series. Last met in '22, Cardinals (-9) trailed 21-10 at HT but won 25-21. Ball St is under first time HC Mike Uremovich returning just 7 starters from LY's 3-9 season. UConn is under 4th year HC Jim Mora, who is in his tenth year in the FBS along with 4 in the NFL. The Huskies return 11 starters from LY's 9-4 team. The Cardinals 1-2 SU & 2-1 ATS as LW they (-3) held on to beat FCS New Hampshire 34-29. They were outscored by Purdue & Auburn by a combined 73-3 but covered as a 45' pt AD vs Auburn. The Huskies are 1-2 SU & 1-1-1 ATS but ore off back to back OT losses. They blew a 14-3 lead over Syracuse & LW allowed new FBS foe Delaware to hit a 43 yd fg as time expired to force OT. Ball St does have a bye on deck but this is a frustrated UConn team that showed no mercy to their FCS foe in the opener winning 59-13 (-28). We look for the more talented & experienced team to get their season back on track here.

Arkansas by 3 over MEMPHIS - These two haven't met since 1998 when Ark won 23-9 (-17'). Hogs are coming off a heartbreaking loss to Ole Miss. They put up 35 points and 526 yards but fumbled inside the UM20 on their final possession and lost by 6. QB Taylen Greene is thriving in Petrino's system, hitting 68% with an 11-2 ratio and is their #1 rusher with 307 (9.6). Memphis is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS this year. They are off a 28-7 win over Troy (-4') where they had a 430-112 yd edge. Memphis is rushing for 218 (5.6). Ark is just 6-24 SU on the road s/18 and Memphis is 49-8 SU at home since '17 and 6-2 as home dogs under Silverfield. The angles favor Memphis but Arkansas' offense has been impressive so we won't call for the outright upset.

NEBRASKA by 8 over Michigan - Since the Huskers joined B10, Michigan is 5-2 SU with 4 straight wins (3-2-2 ATS). Last time here in '23, #2 UM handed Nebraska (+18) a 45-7 loss. Huskers had 10 FDs and only points allowed came with 4:17 left. Michigan will be in its 2nd game with interim HC Biff Boggi. Last week, Michigan dominated in-state rival CMich, 63-3 (-27'), with a 616-139 ydg edge. QB Underwood was 9-24 in his 1st road start and faces a defense allowing just 202 ypg this year in a hostile environment. Huskers have dropped last 2 at home to Michigan ('21 & '23) with last win here in '12. Nebraska allowed at least 32 pts and 400 yds in the last 4 meetings. Huskers 2-6 SU (1-7 ATS) in B10 openers since '17. HC Rhule is 0-6 vs ranked teams with the Huskers, but did have 18-11 FD edge at Ohio State last year! Last week, Nebraska improved to 3-0 with a 59-7 blowout of FCS Houston Chr (-48'). QB Raiola is hitting 78% with a 8-0 ratio after going thru Fr. growing pains last yr. Early line has Mich -27', but we see the Huskers taking this as the Dog.

Since losing the opener at Kansas, Bulldogs have reeled off 3 SU & ATS wins (all 3 went over total). However, the outcomes have been misleading. They beat a Ga Southern tm making a cross-country trip, allowed 528 yds to Oregon St, and handled a bad Southern squad at home. Plus, in 2 gms vs FBS tms, QB EJ Warner has an 0-5 ratio. Hawaii is a completely different tm at home. Warriors are already 3-0 in their own building and covered against Stanford and SH St. Under HC Timmy Chang, they're 14-6-2 ATS at home (9-5-1 as HD). After missing the last 2 gms with an injury, QB Micah Alejado returns this wk. He's by far their best passer and gives the offense its identity. We think Hawaii is the better team, especially in Honolulu and like the home team by double-digits, making it a late night for our Underdog POW!

NOTRE DAME by 31 over Purdue - Irish lead 58-26-2 & have won 5 straight at home (3-2 ATS). Last year at Purdue, ND was off a loss to NIU and was only -7. However, they outgained Boilers 578-162 in 66-7 win (worst loss in Purdue history). Irish 7-1-1 ATS in their last 9 vs B10. Last week, Notre Dame lost to Texas A&M at home in the final moments, 41-40 (-6), falling to 0-2. Purdue has lost 9 straight in the Battle for Shillelagh Trophy (4-5 ATS). In their season road opener, Purdue is 5-5 SU (4-6 ATS) since '15. Last time here in '21, Purdue (+7) trailed ND 17-13 4Q but allowed the final 10 pts in a 27-13 loss. Purdue does have a new HC in Barry Odom. Last week, Purdue lost to USC 33-17 (+20) in both school's B10 opener. ND is 8-5 ATS as a HF the last 3 years and this is Purdue's 1st road game. Early line has ND -26' and, despite the early disappointments, we think the Irish get back on track here.

VIRGINIA by 21 over Stanford - First meeting. Stanford had a huge situational edge last week, hosting BC who was making a cross-country trip and the game started at 10:30 PM ET. Last week Stanford (+13', +440) was one of four outright winners on our 'Big Dogs' (just \$15 on ncsports.com or call 1-800-654-3448). The Cardinal allowed 313 yards in the first half, but a tired BC team mustered just 76 yards in the 2H and BC won 30-20. UVA crushed William & Mary 55-16 (-31). HC Elliott has his best team and they easily could be 3-0 (close loss to NCS). Stanford is now traveling across country and 3 of their 4 trips to the ETZ last year resulted in losses by 21 points or more. UVA isn't a team that we would usually lay over 2 td's with but the situation favors the 'Hoos.

MISSOURI by 24 over South Carolina - Mizzou won 5 straight meetings from '19-'23 and are 6-0 ATS in this series. Major questions for SC in this game with QB LaNorris Sellers a ? after getting hurt in the first week vs Vandy. The Gamecocks fell to 2-1 and we cashed a 3★ on these pages as part of a 4-0 Key Selection day! Luke Doty came in and threw for 148 and 1 int. Mizzou is 3-0 SU/ATS this year. Two weeks ago they were -6' against Kansas and while they needed a late td to cover, they did finish with a 595-226 yd edge. RB Ahmad Hardy leads the SEC with 462 rushing (8.1) and Penn St transfer QB Beau Pribula has hit 76% w/a 7-1 ratio. Mizzou's D is allowing 191 ypg and last week they held Louisiana to just 4 passing yards. A lot going for Mizzou here regardless of who is playing QB so we are taking the Tigers to win by over 3 td's.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 17 over NIU - The Bulldogs have opened 3-0 SU & ATS already surpassing last year's win total. That includes a 20-20 (+6) win over #12 Arizona St. Last ranked in '22 they are RV (unofficially #29 AP/#34 Cch's poll). QB Blake Shapen is avg 241 ypg (68%) with a 6-2 ratio, NIU is off a bye after only losing to now 3-0 Maryland 20-9 (+16') only being outgained 340-271. The Huskies 7th year HC Thomas Hammock has led them to 3 wins over P4 teams the last 4 yrs. That includes handling LY's National Title runner-up Notre Dame their only regular season loss 16-14 as a 28 pt AD. While the Huskies have a home game vs San Diego St on deck, Miss St has a big conference opener hosting Tennessee on deck. Still after LY's 41-17 loss to MAC foe Toledo will not let the Bulldogs look past NIU but they only have to win and get out healthy. So we will take the wily Huskies plus 3 three td's.

James Madison by 3 over LIBERTY - Virginia schools separated by 100 miles meet for the first time as FBS programs. JMU has been sharper so far. Dukers are 1-1 SU & 2-0 ATS and coming off a bye. Their loss was at Louisville (-14') in a game they led 14-6 in the 3Q. Cards scored 3 td's to pull away 28-13 but only had 12 fd's and 264 yds. Liberty, on the other hand, has hit a rough patch. Flames are 0-3 and their only win was over Maine. They lost as a fav last 2 wks to Jax St and Bowling Green. However, they outgained both and were -6 TO's in the losses. Against JSU they had 534 yds. Plus, those were road gms and Liberty is almost unbeatable at home. Under HC Jamey Chadwell, Flames are 14-1 in Lynchburg and have not been a HD. The last time they were a HD in 2022, they beat BYU and UAB outright. Last time they were a dog, they beat Arkansas (-14') in Fayetteville in 2022, 21-19. We have JMU squeaking out a 3pt win so there's line value on a desperate team that thrives in its own house.

KENNESAW ST by 3 over Arkansas St - First meeting. Kennesaw St HC Jerry Mack will be facing his alma mater (class of 2003). We like the job Mack is doing so far in his first yr with the Owls. The team is just 1-2 SU & ATS, with the win coming last week vs Merrimack. But KSU (+17') only lost by 1 pt to Wake Forest in the opener. A defense that returned 8 starters flashed potential against the Deacons and in LW's win. The staff likes the skill set of Wofford transfer QB Amari Odom who came off the bench to complete 12-14 and account for 2 td's. Arkansas St is 1-2 and 2-1 ATS, with an opening week win over SE Missouri. They caught Iowa St in a flat spot LW after the Iowa win a week earlier. Red Wolves actually led 17-16 in the 4Q and only lost by 8 as a 20pt dog. But that was in Jonesboro, and a week earlier they lost at Arkansas (-23), 56-14. KSU is confident after getting Mack his first win. We like them as a HD to win this gm outright.

FIU by 10 over Delaware - This is Delaware's first ever CUSA game. The Blue Hens have already proven they belong by knocking off UConn 44-41 in OT last week. RB JoNathan Silver ran for 179 on 15 carries and WR Kyre Duplessis was 9-161. FIU is off a Shula Bowl win over FAU. The win was their first over their rival since '16. They were actually outgained 312-130 in the 1H but they only trailed 21-17 and won 38-28. HC Willie Simmons has led FIU to a 2-1 start and they only trailed Penn St 10-0 at half two weeks ago. Both teams are coming off big wins and with heat and humidity playing a factor we will go with the home team to win and cover.

WKU by 17 over Nevada - First meeting. WKU is fresh off a bye after losing 45-21 at Toledo. The 'Toppers are led by Abilene Christian transfer QB Maverick McIvor who has a 10-1 ratio. Nevada is 1-2 and just lost at home to another CUSA team, Middle Tennessee. The Wolfpack were held to 49 yards in the 1H against Sac St two weeks ago but won 20-17. They were up 13-0 at half against MT last week and gave up the GW td with just :21 left. Nevada has our #115 pass D (71%, 3-2). The situation favors WKU here so we are going with the home team by over 2 td's.

Boise St by 10 over AIR FORCE - Since '17, Boise St is 6-1 SU & ATS vs Air Force. LTH in '22, Broncos (+2) gave up 271 yds and won 19-14. BSU is 1-1 and coming off a bye. Under 3rd yr HC

Spencer Danielson, they're 3-0 SU & ATS on extra rest. Broncos have split their first 2 gms. They lost the opener to USF (+5), 34-7, in a game that wasn't as one-sided as the score indicates. In fact, they were +6 yds and +10 fd's. Before the break, BSU hammered E Washington (+30'), 51-14, in a gm that was more emblematic of the reigning MWC champs. AF has played twice, beating Bucknell before losing LW to Utah St (+4). The 49-30 loss to the Aggies could reset expectations for the Falcons. They gave up 473 yds to a tm that looked like it was going through a rebuild under new HC Bronco Mendenhall. That D won't stop QB Maddux Madsen and a deep group of backs running behind a terrific line. Boise St maintains its dominance of AF with a 10pt road win.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE ST by 10 over Marshall - Former CUSA rivals meet for the first time since '21. MT is 3-1 SU/ATS, with all 3 coming as outright upsets. This is the first time MT has been favored against Marshall since '16. Bettors threw MT in the trash after they were dominated by Austin Peay in the opener, finishing with just 153 yards in a 34-14 loss. They were only down 14-10 at half at Wisconsin before giving up 4 2nd half td's and last week they were down 13-0 at half and rallied to beat Nevada on the road. Marshall is in a rebuilding year. They started 0-2 including a loss to Missouri St where they were outgained 474-274. Last week they beat Eastern Kentucky 38-7 (-15). MT is 0-7 ATS at home under HC Mason but we think they've turned things around since the embarrassing opener. The wrong team is favored here and we are calling for MT to pull their 2nd straight outright upset.

LOUISIANA TECH by 7 over Southern Miss - These two were CUSA rivals that met 11 times between '10 and '21. SM won the last meeting in '21 35-19 as 15' pt dogs. LT switched QB's last week vs NMSU and their offense exploded for 49 points and 574 yards. Blake Baker threw for 182 and rushed for 103. SMiss started the Charles Huff era with a loss to Miss St but they've won their last two including last week over App State 38-22. They had a 99 IR return td off a tipped pass and int'd App St at the SM3. LT's D is allowing just 12 ppg/315 ypg and even held LSU to 23 pts and 365 yards 2 wks ago. Cumbie has the offense going now and LT is 11-8 SU at home but only laying a fg here. Bulldogs win by a touchdown.

Washington by 24 over WASHINGTON ST - It's the 117th Apple Cup. UW leads 76-34-4. Huskies (-6) lost LY in Seattle, 24-19, but have won last 4 in Pullman (4-0 ATS). Last time here in '22, UW (-2) broke open 35-33 3Q game with 16 unanswered in 51-33 win. Cougars are 3-12 vs their in-state rival since '09 (5-10 ATS) w/ 4 straight losses at home. The favorite is 10-5 ATS in the last 15 meetings. However, a goal-line stand in the final min preserved WSU's upset win. Washington had a 452-381 yard edge and are a Revenge Play. Last week, Washington had a bye - it blew out FCS UC Davis, 70-10, in its previous game. Last week, Washington St was North Texas, 59-10 (+5), after trailing 42-3 at half. Cougars had 4 2Q TO's and were -5 for the game. QB Williams is hitting 69% with a 2-0 ratio, RB Coleman had 288 (7.4) rush with 7 TD's and WR Boston has 142 (14.2) receiving. UW's D is allowing just 242 ypg. They have struggled on the road under Fisch but they get revenge here. Early line has UW -20' and we believe it will cover.

VANDERBILT by 35 over Georgia St - Revenge spot for Vandy who lost to Georgia St 36-32 (-9'). Following that game they nearly upset Mizzou then beat Bama and Kentucky B2B weeks as DD Dogs. This year Vandy is 3-0 SU/ATS with upset wins over VTech and South Carolina. Last week SC did lose QB Sellers for the entire 2H and Vandy pulled away, 31-7 (+3). QB Pavia is back to his old tricks, posting numbers (73%, 7-2, 129 rush) and pulling upsets but now Vandy is laying almost 4 td's. GST is 1-2 SU/ATS and their only win was against lowly Murray St. Two weeks ago they did have a 313-192 yd edge at half vs Memphis but lost 38-16. Two different QB's played last week, with Cameron Brown hitting 9-11 for 101 and 3 td's. Hard to lay this many points since Vandy is 2-6 as a HF but they did cover the opener, beating Charleston Southern 45-3 (-37') and they only have Utah St on deck so no look ahead and plenty of focus.

TEXAS by 45 over Sam Houston - One more shot for Arch Manning to look the part before entering SEC play. These schools are just 160 miles apart. The only prior meeting was won by Texas 56-3 in '06. Phil Longo is still looking for his first win as HC of Sam Houston (0-3 SU/ATS). The Barkats have suffered 17 point losses to WKU, UNLV and Hawaii and are -122 ypg. Manning should have his best game against a pass D that is allowing 68% with an 8-2 ratio. Texas is 0-3 ATS after only beating UTEP 27-10 but SH looks like they are they are in bad shape and Texas won't hold back if they get things going.

UTEP by 14 over ULM - Second meeting. UTEP won in Monroe in 2020, 31-6, as a 9pt dog. Miners are in their second year under HC Scotty Waldren. Their only win is over UT Martin (+6'), 42-17, but they covered the last 2. LW at Texas, the Miners (+41') allowed just 340 yds in a 27-10 loss. The D played well, and we like Waldren's offensive trio of QB Malachi Nelson (PS#2), RB Hahsaun Wilson (11.1 ypc) and All-CUSA WR Kenny Odom. ULM is also led by a 2nd yr HC, Bryant Vincent, and has split its first 2 gms with St Francis and Alabama (0-2 ATS). Warhaws did not play well vs a bad St Francis squad and lost to the Tide 73-0. ULM lacks the weapons to stretch a defense that's building confidence after forcing UT's Arch Manning into 10 straight incompletions in Austin. UTEP doesn't get many chances to flex its muscles against a weaker opponent. Like Week 2 against UT Martin, Miners will turn this opportunity into a comfortable DD win.

California by 9 over SAN DIEGO ST - Cal is 3-0 ATS in this series including a 31-10 (-17') win last year. SDSU is fresh off a bye. They lost to Wash St 36-13 (+1') and were outgained 396-215 two weeks ago. Cal has been impressive in their 3-0 start. They caught Minnesota w/o star RB Darius Taylor last week and won 27-14 (+2). QB Jaron-Keawe Sagapolutele has been the difference for the Bears, hitting 67% w/a 6-1 ratio. Cal has their ACC opener at BC on deck. Wilcox much prefers the underdog role and is only 4-13-1 ATS as a DD Favorite. The situation greatly favors SDSt and we think the underdog Aztecs stay just within the number.

4★ TAMPA BAY over NY Jets – Home opener after two road wins, and TB brings form: outgained HOU 360–266 with 169 rush, 0 TO, TB QB Mayfield 215–2-0, TB RB Rachaad White the late game-winner, and TB WR Egubaka a 20-yd TD. NYJ managed just 154 yds vs BUF (0-for-11 3rd, 4 sk allowed); NYJ QB Fields is in concussion protocol, and if NYJ QB Taylor goes, this one could get out of hand quick. Angles: TB vs AFC 3-0 SU/ATS, NYJ vs NFC 0-5 SU/ATS, NYJ after 14+ pt losses 3-8 SU (2-9 ATS); TB is 3-1 SU at home and finally gets their first game at Raymond James. H2H is light (2021: TB 28-24, no cover), but current YPG/TO and QB health point to the fav. **FORECAST: Tampa Bay by 17**

3★ INDIANAPOLIS over Tennessee – IND owns this matchup (4-0 SU/ATS vs TEN) and just posted a 473-yd, 0-TO clinic with IND QB Daniel Jones 316-1-0 and IND RB Jonathan Taylor 25-165, behind protection that allowed 1 sack and no punts. TEN is on an eight-game slide and last week the TEN defense allowed 421 yds while the TEN offense gave up 5 sacks; TEN QB Cam Ward 175-1-0 also lost a fumble and a 57-yd PR TD was wiped out by penalty. Angles stack up: TEN 1-8 SU (0-9 ATS) at home, 0-5 SU/ATS in B2B home games, 0-4 SU/ATS as a home dog, and 0-4 SU/ATS after back-to-back losses. With IND WR Michael Pittman Jr. and Alec Pierce facing a secondary that just gave up 298 pass yds (Davante 6-106-1; Nacua 7-91), the Colts' balanced offense and trench edge point to a comfortable road result. **FORECAST: Indianapolis by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SEATTLE over New Orleans – Recent H2H leans NO (2-0 SU last 5 yrs), but current form points to SEA at home. Last wk, SEA handled PIT 454–267 behind SEA QB Darnold 295–2-2, SEA RB Walker III 13–105–1, and a special-teams TD; the defense picked Rodgers twice and held PIT to 64 rush yds. NO narrowed late vs SF with NO QB Rattler 207–3–0, but 8 penalties, 3 sacks allowed, and a Kamara fumble undercut a 332–324 yardage edge; the OL is banged up (RG Cesar Ruiz concussion). Angles: NO away 1–5 SU/ATS, off B2B losses 1–7 SU (2–6 ATS), and 0–4 SU as a 7+ dog; SEA has a small sample as a big fav (2–1 SU / 1–2 ATS). With Seattle's vertical game back and the 12th Man noise factor, this sets up for a comfortable margin. **FORECAST: Seattle by 14**

OTHER PLAYS

Miami Dolphins vs BUFFALO BILLS – Streak-heavy TNF: BUF has taken 6 straight vs MIA (3-1 ATS) and won 7 straight Thursday games (5-2 ATS); both bring TNF UNDER runs (BUF 7, MIA 5). Last wk, BUF controlled NYJ wire-to-wire (332–154 total; 172 rush), with BUF RB James Cook 22-132-2 and BUF QB Allen adding 59 rush yds on a turnover-free day. MIA generated 418 yds at NE (MIA QB Tagovailoa 315-2-1; MIA WR Hill 6-109), but a 74-yd PR TD was immediately answered by a 90-yd KR allowed, then a late INT and 4 sacks stalled the rally; through two wks the defense hasn't forced a punt. Angles: BUF 11-0 at home (8-2 ATS) with two straight home overs; MIA road 1-4 SU/ATS (Under 5-1); as a 10+ dog the past 5 yrs MIA is 0-3 SU (1-1-1 ATS).

CAROLINA by 1 over Atlanta – Split series lately (2–2 SU/ATS), but last wk profiles diverged. ATL leaned on defense and the ground game vs MIN, finishing +118 yds (330–212) with 211 rush as ATL RB Bijan Robinson (22–143) and ATL RB Tyler Allgeier (8–55, TD) controlled tempo; the D grabbed 2 INT and went 3-for-3 on RZ stops. CAR rallied late in ARI behind CAR QB Bryce Young (328–3–2) for 389 total yds, but the run game stayed light (61 rush) and the OL took hits (C Austin Corbett knee, RG Robert Hunticeps). Angles: CAR at home 4–1 ATS and 4–0 ATS as a home dog; ATL on the road 1–5 ATS and 0–5 ATS in B2B away spots; CAR off B2B losses 3–1 ATS. Matchup keys: ATL's run script vs CAR's patched interior, and whether Young-to-Renfrow/Marshall can manufacture enough chunk plays against an ATL secondary that just limited explosives.

Washington by 3 over LAS VEGAS – H2H has leaned one way (WAS 4–0 SU/ATS vs LV) and the venue trends match it (WAS at home 4–0 SU/ATS). Last wk, LV's offense never got on track (218 total, 3 INT, 3 sacks; LV QB Geno Smith 24/43 for 180) while LAC hit two explosives through the air and controlled field position. WAS started slow at GB but found late rhythm: WAS QB Jayden Daniels 24/42 for 200 with 2 late TDs (Ertz, Deebo) after taking 4 sacks; run game only 63 yds as they chased. Angles: WAS as a fav 5–0 SU (3–2 ATS); LV has been a dog in both games (1–1 SU/ATS). Injury watch til kickoff: Daniels (knee) day-to-day—if he can't go, WAS QB Marcus Mariota would start.

Green Bay by 10 over CLEVELAND – H2H leans GB (4–0 SU, 3–1 ATS) and wk2 form backs it: GB controlled at WSH with a 411–263 yard edge as GB QB Jordan Love went 292–2–0, GB TE Tucker Kraft 6–124–1, and GB RB Josh Jacobs 23–84–1; defense added 4 sacks with zero giveaways. CLE was outclassed at BAL despite 293–270 yards, undone by a blocked punt TD, 5 sacks allowed, and late turnovers; CLE QB Joe Flacco finished 199–1–1 as drives stalled. Angles: CLE at home 0–3 SU (1–2 ATS) and off B2B losses 0–4 SU/ATS; GB as an 8+ fav 15–1 SU (9–7 ATS). Note: GB WR Jayden Reed (collarbone) is out, but Love distributed it well and GB still put together multiple long TD drives. Even if this tightens, Green Bay's pass rush and cleaner execution should carry the day.

Cincinnati by 3 over MINNESOTA – CIN turns to Jake Browning, who steadied things vs JAX (21/32, 241, 2 TD, 3 INT) as the Bengals posted a 453–382 yard edge behind Ja'Marr Chase's 14-165-1 and Joe Mixon's 97 rush; Joe Burrow (toe) is out ~3 months. MIN shifts to Carson Wentz with J.J. McCarthy (ankle) out after managing just 212 yds and going 0-for-3 in the red zone at ATL (Justin Jefferson 3-81), and the RB room takes a hit with Aaron Jones now on IR. Trends: Bengals 4-0 SU (2-2 ATS) away and 3-0 SU (2-1 ATS) after back-to-back wins; MIN 0-2 SU/ATS as a fav, and 1-3 SU (1-2-1 ATS) H2H. With CIN holding the stronger backup QB and the Chase mismatch, we still side with the Bengals in a tight one.

LA Rams by 1 over PHILADELPHIA – Two narrow PHI wins so far (by 4 and 3; 279 total yds at KC) have leaned on defense and situational ball, but they now face a Rams offense that just posted a 421–279 yard edge at TEN behind Matthew Stafford (298, 2 TD) and Davante Adams/Puka Nacua. Trend tape is tight: H2H PHI 3-1 SU (2-2 ATS); EAGLES at home 11-0 SU (8-2 ATS), while LAR have traveled well at 6-1 SU (7-0 ATS) on the road and are 5-0 ATS as a dog, plus 3-0 SU (2-1 ATS) in B2B away spots. PHI as a fav is 4-0 SU (2-2 ATS), but CB Ahkello Witherspoon's injury aside, LAR's pass game has looked crisp enough to challenge an Eagles secondary that's been bend-but-close-out. With PHI's margins thin and LAR's road ATS heater we expect Stafford to pull out a last second win here.

Pittsburgh by 7 over NEW ENGLAND – Recent H2H leans NE (3-0 SU / 2-0-1 ATS), but context tilts back: PIT fits a strong road-fav angle (away fav <-3; 7-1 SU/ATS), while NE off a win has been a fade spot (0-10 SU / 2-6-2 ATS). Week 2 snapshots: PIT stalled after halftime and special teams miscues flipped the game; NE needed a 98-yard KR TD and a late takeaway to survive despite being outgained 418–328. Good spot for Rodgers to bounce back and Pittsburgh's pass rush should bother a protection unit that just allowed 2 sacks and multiple hits. Expect the Steelers to control the explosives and finish a few more drives.

Houston by 4 over JACKSONVILLE – H2H and trends tilt slightly HOU: Texans have taken 4 straight in JAX (4-0 SU, 3-1 ATS), while JAX at home is 0-4 SU/ATS; HOU off B2B losses has been a strong response team (4-0 SU, 6-0 ATS). In Wk2, HOU played clean (0 TOs) and got a late 25-yd Nick Chubb TD to go ahead, but finished with 266 yds and couldn't close it out. JAX posted 382 total yds with 3 pass TD yet let chunk plays and late swings decide it. Small edge to HOU's bounce-back profile and recent road success in this matchup.

LA Chargers by 7 over DENVER – Trends lean hard LAC: at home 4-2 SU/ATS, as a favorite 4-1 SU/ATS, and 2-0 SU/ATS vs DEN last year; meanwhile DEN on the road is 0-4 SU/ATS and as a dog 0-6 SU (1-5 ATS). On the field, LAC just delivered a dominant showing with 3 takeaways/3 sacks and a clean Herbert line (19/27, 242-2-0) in a 317–218 yard edge. DEN flashed early with Nix (206-3-1) but the late-game sequence—red-zone INT, penalties, a 42-yarder off the upright, then a leverage flag gifting a second-chance game-winner—spotlight their close-out issues. With LAC pairing turnover pressure and efficient QB play against a DEN side still stumbling in critical moments, the projection favors the hosts to finish stronger.

CHICAGO by 3 over Dallas – Only one H2H in the last 5 years (DAL 1-0 SU/ATS, 49–29), and the trend board cuts both ways: CHI has dropped 6 straight at home (2-3-1 ATS) but is 5-2 SU/ATS as a home favorite, while DAL is 2-2 SU (3-1 ATS) away. On-field form: DAL just won a 40–37 OT track meet (495 total yds; Dak 361-2-1, CeeDee 9-112) but that defense was torched for 539 by NYG, whereas CHI comes off a 52–21 setback at DET (291 yds, 8 penalties) though the Williams-to-Odonuzo connection flashed (207-2-1 and 7-128-2). Situationally, CHI after a 21+ loss is 0-6 SU (0-5-1 ATS), yet in the lone instance they were favored after such a defeat, they won but missed the cover. With the home-favorite profile and DAL's recent defensive issues, we lean to CHI to squeeze this at home.

Arizona by 3 over SAN FRANCISCO – Trend board leans ARI: they're 5-0 ATS as an away dog and have taken the last two H2H (now 2-4 SU/ATS overall), while SF was 4-5 SU/ATS at home LY; ARI away is 1-4 SU but 3-2 ATS, and off b2b wins last year ARI went 2-1 SU/ATS. On-field, ARI built a 27–3 cushion vs CAR behind a defensive score, a Rondale Moore TD, and a steady day from Kyler (173-1-1, 45 rush), but the secondary gave up 328 pass yds before a late stop: Conner's 66 rush yds helped salt it. SF moved to 2-0 with Mac Jones stepping in (279-3-0) and the defense closing with a 4th-down sack, even as NO edged them in total yds (332–324) and SF played without Purdy/Kittle. With ARI's away-dog cover streak versus SF's recent home profile and injury questions, we're siding with the visitors to get it done.

Kansas City vs NY GIANTS – KC brings strong bounce-back angles (after back-to-back losses: 5-0, 4-0-1 ATS; and 2-0 SU/ATS as an away favorite) and a defense that just held PHI to 279 yards, while the offense has opened slowly (37 points through two games; Mahomes 187-1-1 last wk). NYG counter with a surging air attack (Wilson 450-3-1, Nabers 9-167-2; 539 total yards at DAL) and the last H2H saw KC 1-0 SU but 0-1 ATS. Trend-wise the home ledger has been rough for NYG lately (1-7 SU, 2-6 ATS), yet the current passing production and protection (2 sacks allowed) suggest they can trade blows. KC's historical angles vs. NYG's explosive passing attack has this one with aimed to be a great night of football. Get the Sunday Night Marquee on Sunday by 11:00am ET Call 1-800-654-3448

Detroit vs BALTIMORE – DET's offense just erupted (515 yds, 8.8 YPP; Goff 334-5-0; St. Brown 9-115-3) and the Lions have handled Monday nights (3-0 SU/ATS). BAL counters with a surge of its own (41 vs CLE with 21 in the 4th; Jackson 225-4-0) and the long-run H2H leans Ravens (DET 0-5 SU, 1-4 ATS), though the two most recent meetings over seven years tilted DET (2-0 SU, 1-1 ATS). Trend tape cuts both ways: BAL is perfect recently on Mondays (4-0 SU/ATS) but at home on Monday the covers haven't come (0-3 ATS), and this is a B2B home spot where BAL sits 2-1 SU (1-2 ATS). DET's pass game stayed clean (0 sacks allowed) and explosive. Both sides come off blowout against DIV OPP and if these offenses show up again, we're due for an electric game. **Remember on Monday Nights you can get a \$back+ guarantee!
