The KSU win lost some impact after Cats opened 1-3. Cyclones looked gassed before the break, only beating Arkansas St 24-16 as a 21pt fav, and will really benefit from the extra wk of rest. Arizona is ahead of schedule in Brent Brennan's 2nd ssn. After going 4-8 LY, Wildcats have started 3-0 SU & ATS incl a common opponent win over Kansas St (+219 yds!). However, this is their first game on the road. Cats went 1-4 ATS as a road dog in Brennan's debut LY. Iowa St has the better D, greater balance on offense, and is battle-tested with the win over instate rival Iowa. And while both tms had byes, the Cyclones will benefit more after playing 4 straight weeks and opening in Ireland. They'll be the more physical team up front and will pull away in the 2nd half!

**FORECAST: IOWA ST by 20**

**3★ TEXAS A&M over Auburn** - A&M is out for legit revenge after losing in 4 OT's last year, 43-41 (-2). The Aggies are 3-0 and had the bye week to recoup after their upset win over Notre Dame. Auburn also started 3-0 but last week they allowed 10 sacks and fortunately for us, the Tigers gave up a Safety on their final drive, which gave Oklahoma a cover, winning 24-17 (-6). Aggies are only 4-12 ATS under Elko but they did go 2-0 as a HF vs SEC foes including a 31 points win over #9 Mizzou and 15 point win over #8 LSU last year. Auburn is playing B2B road games in tough SEC environments. The Oline is a big issue (17 sks all d) and A&M already has 9 sacks. Aggies are turning a corner here and are a legit playoff contender!

**FORECAST: TEXAS A&M by 17**

**3★ AIR FORCE over Hawaii** - Warriors are making their first trip to AF since 2016 (won 34-27 as 16'pt dog). They dropped to 3-2 last wk with a tough loss to Fresno St. Hawaii led start of 4Q and were +14yds but they turned it over 4 times, and the potential gm-typing 2pt conv with 10 seconds left failed. The offense, usually Hawaii's calling card, ranks 8th in the MWC at only 22ppg. Plus, under HC Chang, Warriors just 2-16 when playing on the mainland. Falcons have dropped b2b conference gms SU & ATS. They allowed 49pts apiece in losses to Utah St (+4) and Boise St (-10), and the Broncos ran wild for 282yds (9.1ypc). AF does lead the MWC in scoring at 38.7ppg and is getting pass support to its mainstay ground gm. Falcons' defensive woes are less likely to get exposed this wk by Hawaii, especially on the road. AF controls the clock and evens its record with a 2 td win.

**2★ ILLINOIS over USC** - This is USC's 1st trip to Champaign since '96 (55-3 win). Since '13, USC 1-13 SU/1-13 ATS when playing in ETZ or CTZ (0-3 SU & ATS LY). First meeting as Big Ten foes. Last met in '08 Rose Bowl (USC won 49-17). USC is just 4-13 ATS as an AD L11Y. Illinois opened 3-0 SU/ATS, including a 45-19 win at Duke (+5 TO's). LW Illinois was demolished by Indiana, 63-10 (-7). Illinois was w/o CB Scott and lost leading tkl'r Miles Scott (targeting). USC put up 66 points in 2 home games vs G5 foes, then had a 3-hour weather delay and only beat Purdue, 33-17. Last week, USC led 24-20 at half with a 355-173 yd edge & had leads of 31-10 & 45-24. Michigan St got a back-door TD with 2:39 left to make it a 45-31 USC win (-19). Both QB's Maeva and Altmeyer have a 9-0 ratio. Early line favors USC -7. While USC may have more talent, the travel thing is real, so we're calling for Illinois to bounce back and pull the upset.

**2★ Tennessee over MISSISSIPPI ST** - Vols making their first trip to Starkville since '12. Tenn is 7-1 SU in this series going back to 1995. Last year Tenn was -25' and held MSU to a ssn low 271 yards but the Vols had 0 td's in 6 red zone trips and only won 33-14. This year's Vols offense is much more explosive. They are #4 in the FBS in scoring offense (53.5 ppg) and #7 in total offense (554 ypg). The Vols have yet to be held below 41 points. Their win over Syracuse in wk1 looks even better and they missed a GW fg vs Georgia. Last week we cashed our 4★ Top Totals play on Over 69 in Tenn/UAB (LP Totals now 12-3 this year!!!). The Vols put up 56 points and the Over cashed in the 3Q. Tenn led 56-10 but gave up 2 scores including with :48 left for a Blazers backdoor. Miss St is 4-0 SU/ATS and +180 ypg. They did give up 251 (4.9) rush vs Arizona St and Tenn is rushing for 216 (5.2). Heupel is 8-4 as an AF while MSU is 3-13-1 as HD. Vols offense is too much and the defense is healthier this week.

**Army vs EAST CAROLINA** - ECU had won 7 straight meetings from '98-'04 but Army won the only recent meeting last year, 45-28 (-17). Army is 1-2 and all 3 games they've played have been decided by 7 points or less. The upset Kansas St in their only road game. Last week Army was +2 vs NTexas. They trailed 28-7 Q2 but tied it with :09 left and lost in OT. ECU covered their first 3 games. Last week they were +6' vs BYU. They trailed 27-6 4Q and lost 34-13 but yards were nearly even. The Pirates faced both Army and Navy last year, losing by 17 & 14. They are a fg home dog here. Call 1-800-654-3448 or go to NCSports.com to get our Thursday College Marquee for \$15.

### FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 26th

**Florida St by 14 over VIRGINIA** - UVA has won 2 of the last 3 meetings but these two haven't met since '19. The home team was 0-4 ATS and the last 7 meetings have gone Under. FSU has looked unstoppable this year, upsetting Bama in the opener then crushed East Texas A&M and Kent St by a combined 143-13. UVA has also been impressive this year, they've won 3 games by 28 points or more and their only loss was at NCSt 35-31 (+3) and they had a 514-416 yd edge. The 'Noles D has held all 3 foes to their season low yards this year. UVA is putting up 565 ypg and QB Chandler Morris has an 8-1 ratio but they've yet to see a defense anywhere near FSU's talent level. FSU has our #6 pass D while UVA's is only #88. FSU is on a mission after their 2-10 season and they are laying single-digits here so we are backing the road chalk.

**ARIZONA ST by 3 over TCU** - First meeting s/rf 1975 1975. Both teams riding high off big Week 4 wins. TCU moved to 3-0 and recaptured the Iron Skillet with a 35-24 win over rival SMU. Frogs (-7) outgained Mustangs 517-384 and got the cover with 2 long td passes in final 9 mins. Behind QB Josh Hoover (11-2 ratio), TCU is 2-0 ATS vs FBS opp (UNC & SMU) and has amassed more than 500 yds in both of those wins. Defending Big 12 champ ASU has rebounded from a crushing Week 2 loss at Mississippi St by beating and covering against Texas St and Baylor. The Baylor win was especially meaningful because it came in Waco and the Sun Devils held the high-scoring Bears to 24 pts and a season-low 357 yds. ASU limited big plays in the passing gm which will be critical against Hoover and top WR Eric McAlister (8-254-3 LW). Since the start of '24, ASU has won 8 straight in Tempe (7-0 ATS vs FBS opp). We think ASU remains hot at home, handing TCU its first loss of the year in a single-digit victory.

**Houston by 17 over OREGON ST** - Tms meeting for first time since 1970. Houston 3-0 first time since 2016, beginning Willie Fritz's second ssn with wins over SF Austin, Rice, and Colorado. Cougars 3-0 ATS and coming off a bye and this is their first trip outside Houston (Fritz 15-7 ATS as AF at this level). The D ranks top 10 nationally in ypg (224) and ypp (3.7) and the offense is coming off its best gm (36pts & 431 yds vs Buffs). Oregon St is also led by a 2nd yr coach, Trent Bray, but is headed in opposite direction. Beavers 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS, covering this past weekend in 41-7 loss to Oregon (-35) in Civil War. They were held to 147 yds and 8 td's, and the offense has avg 1.9 ypc in 3 gms with P4 defenses. OSU lacks the offensive balance against the discipline and physicality of the Cougar D. Rested Houston keeps OSU reeling with a 17pt road victory.

### SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 27th

**OHIO by 10 over Bowling Green** - MAC Opener for both but BG has a bye on deck. Former divisional rivals last met in '23 when Ohio (-13) won 38-7. Both have first year HC's. BG returns just 6 returning starters (1 on Def) while Ohio returns 10 (7 on Off). Both are 2-2 SU with BG 4-0 ATS & Ohio 3-1 ATS with only non-cover was LW as a 30' pt HF cruising to a 52-35 win over Gardner-Webb. While the Bobcats main weapon is QB Parker Navarro throwing for 218 ypg (66% with 6-3 ratio (all 3 int in win over WV) and is their #2 rusher (255, 6.2). WR Chase Hendricks leads the FBS with 456 rec yds (16.3 ypc). BG former ND/Ariz St/Missouri QB Drew Pine is avg 165 ypg (64%, 5-2) with 26 rush (1.5) while top WR Jyrin Johnson leads with just 159 (14.5). BG has the better scoring Def (23.5 vs 29.0 ppg), but Ohio has better overall Def (266 vs 355 ypg) despite facing the tougher schedule (#17-#55) and only trailed #1 Ohio St 13-3 at HT. Both are play on teams this year and while we expect the HT to prevail, we also expect it close to the line.

**JAMES MADISON by 12 over Georgia Southern** - Kickoff of the SBC schedule for both league contenders. GS won last yr, 28-14, as a 10pt dog, but lost LTH in 2023, 41-13, getting 6 pts. Eagles have rebounded from an 0-2 start (0-2 ATS on trips to Calif) with wins over Jacksonville St and Maine. They covered both gms and scored 86 total pts behind the running of OJ Arnold who went over 200 rush yds in b2b gms. JMU is back home for the first time in almost a month. Dukes are 2-1 SU and 3-0 ATS, with the under cashing in all 3 gms. In their lone loss at Louisville (-14), they only gave up 264 yds and led in the 3Q. Last wk at Liberty, which is always tough at home, JMU (-9') allowed only 233 yds in 31-13 win. Dukes are well coached, especially on defense, and will control the clock with RB's Wayne Knight, Ayo Adeyi, and George Pettaway (all avg 5+ ypc). Dukes will slow down Arnold but GSU stays within the line which sits over 2 td's.

**TOLEDO by 24 over Akron** - Rockets are 11-3 SU vs Zips (all 3 losses on road) with the home team winning & covering L/3. Toledo is looking for revenge as LY Akron (+8') hit a 72 yd td on their first play from scrimmage and later led 14-0 4Q. Toledo tied it with 3:26 left but missed a potential GW fg as time expired (3rd miss fg) and lost in OT 21-14. After only losing at UAB 31-28 (+11'), Akron (-8') cruised to a 51-7 win over Duquesne LW. Toledo opener the season 3-0 ATS only losing by 8 (+10) at KY, covering their next 2 gms both as a HF by 17+ vs WKU & Morgan St. Then LW in their MAC opener at WM, the Rockets (-14) struggled on offense. Despite throwing 2 int's their first 3 drives UT led 13-0 in 3Q but had three 3&outs & a SOD (4 pl) in their last 5 drives. They allowed a td & GW 2 pt conv w/52 left to lose 14-13. UT's offense is avg just 14.5 ppg on road but 52.3 ppg at home. UT's defense held KY to 24 and allowed just 11.7 ppg L/3. That is not good news for Akron who vs poor defenses put up 39.5 ppg but were shutout their f/2 vs good defense. Look for Toledo to bounce back in a big way here.

**Utah by 17 over WEST VIRGINIA** - Utah making its first-ever trip to Morgantown. Utes will be looking to rebound from a disappointing 34-10 home loss last wk to Texas Tech. They got to within 3 in the 4Q despite being outgained 484-263. However, Utah ran out of gas and allowed 3 unanswered td's in the final 8:29. The Red Raiders were the more physical team, which HC Whittingham admitted was a major disappointment. WVU fell to 2-2 with last wk's 41-10 lost at Kansas (-13). On the road, the Mountaineers are 0-2 SU & ATS incl a loss at Ohio. They scored 10 pts in each of those gms. However, at home they're 2-0 SU/ATS highlighted by a Week 3 upset of rival Pitt (-7'). This is Utah's longest road trip of the season and Morgantown is always tough on visitors. But Utah knows the importance of bouncing back quickly. They have a bye next so they'll let it all hang out and play with the urgency and physicality Whittingham demands. Utah will rely on its edge up front to get back on track with a 17pt conference road win.

**OLD DOMINION by 20 over Liberty** - Virginia schools separated by 190 miles. Lib 4-0 SU/ATS all-time vs ODU, with most recent win in '23 (38-10 as 13'pt fav). However, this is shaping up to be the Flames' worst tm in a decade. Liberty is 1-3 SU/0-4 ATS, with their only win over Maine. They lost b2b road gms to Jax St (+6) and BG (+5'). And when they returned home LW to host JMU (-9'), the offense sunk to a new ssn-low with 233 yds and 75 yds through the air. The 2-1 Monarchs are coming off a bye (4-1 SU & ATS off byes since '21) and still basking in their 45-26 demolition of VT (-5'). They're 3-0 ATS incl a 27-14 loss to Indiana (-23'), which has scored 56, 73, and 63 since facing the Monarchs. ODU has not been a DD fav vs an FBS opp under HC Rahne so this is uncharted territory. Still, they're confident and playing well behind QB Colton Joseph and the D. ODU stays hot and keeps Liberty skidding with a resounding home win.

**Memphis by 17 over FAU** - These two meet for the first time as AAC foes. Memphis won the last meeting 25-10 (-8') in the Montgomery Bowl. The Tigers are 4-0 SU/ATS this year. They were the home dog against Arkansas last week. The Hogs led 28-10 2Q but held Ark to just 3 points the rest of the game. Memphis went up 32-31 with 4:51 left and Ark fumbled on the Mem9 on the final drive. FAU is -8 TO's in their 2 losses at Maryland and FIU. New HC Zach Kittley brought in WKU's QB Caden Veltkamp who has thrown 8 td passes but also 7 int's and he faces a Memphis D that has 6 int's. Memphis looks like a legit playoff contender for the G5 spot. They are rushing for 236 (5.9) led by Sutton Smith (394, 7.4) and QB Lewis is a dual threat (807 pass, 293 rush). Memphis has already covered twice as road favorites and they are laying just under 2 td's. We will ride the streak with the red-hot Tigers!

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 3 over San Diego St** - Both have Conf opener on deck. Aztecs are 6-0 in series incl LTH ('16) but failed to cover their last mtg in '17. This is San Diego's longest trip East this season. SDSU is 11-2-1 SU vs MAC covering last 4, but LY lost 22-21 (+1) at CM. NIU last hosted a MWC tm in '21 losing 50-43 (+6) vs Wyoming but beat Fresno St LY 28-20 (-3) in 2 OT in the Potato Bowl. Aztecs are 2-0 SU & ATS at home with 2 shutout wins including their shocking upset of Cal LW 34-0 (+14). However in their only road game, they lost 36-13 (+1) at Washington St. After just getting by Holy Cross 19-17 (-13) in their opener, NIU gave Maryland their closest game of the season only losing 20-9 (-16'). Then LW at Miss St (24) only trailed 14-10 at HT but were int's at MS20 & SOD twice incl at MS36 (MS 3 scoring drives under 64 yd) and led 38-10. SDSU LW benefitted from +3 TO including 35 yd FR & 97 yd IR td's as they were out FD'd & only finished with 321-289 yd edge. Now off a Huge win making the long trip East, look for NIU who handed Notre Dame their only regular ssn loss LY to pull an upset of their own

**ARKANSAS ST by 3 over Notre Dame** - Two desperate teams meet with two losses and their season on the brink of disaster. ND lost to Miami in the opener then had A&M beat until they missed a PAT and allowed a td on 4th & 11. Hogs are off 2 straight close losses to Ole Miss and Memphis. In both games they were driving for the game-winning score and fumbled. QB Taylen Greene is in his 2nd year under OC Petrino and faces a ND pass D that allowed 360 and 303 in their L/2. Greene has topped 300 yards in all 4 games, has a 12-4 ratio and is their #1 rusher with 360 (8.2). Their offense has put up the most yards that all 4 opponents have allowed but their defense has allowed 475 and 489 the last two weeks. ND RB Love has 284 (5.5) and Ark just allowed Memphis to rush for 290 (7.1). Pittman is 23-11-1 with 9 outright upsets as an underdog and this game looks like it will come down to the wire. Hogs hand the Irish their 3rd loss.

**BOSTON COLLEGE by 13 over California** - These two meet for the first time since 1986. Cal is making their first trip to the ETZ this year. Last year Cal won at Wake Forest but lost at FSU and Pitt (2-1 ATS). BC is fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they were in a tough situation, playing an 11 PM ET game at Stanford. They were tied at half 20-20 but had just 69 2H yards and lost 30-20 (-10'). The Bears were 3-0 going into last week. They were -14 at San Diego St. Cal trailed 13-0 at half, then SDSU got a 35 yd fumble ret td and a 97 yd Pick-6 as Cal lost 34-0. True fresh QB Jaron-Keawe Sagapolutele had a 6-1 ratio in their first 3 games but was only 17-38-208 and 2 int's LW. BC's Dylan Lonergan has a 9-1 ratio and has topped 300 pass yards in all 3 games. BC was in a bad situation two weeks ago but now they have a big situation edge so we are going with the home team by DD's.

**Connecticut by 7 over BUFFALO** - Bulls had won & covered 2 straight in series ('12 & '13) but LY lost 47-3 (+16) being outgained 537-198. UConn's WR Skyler Bell is #2 in FBS (445 rec). RB Cam Edwards is #5 FBS (500 rush) and QB Joe Fagnano is #19 (1046 pass) with a 6-0 ratio. They are #93 in scoring D (37.3 ppg). However 32 of those pts were in final minute or in OT (two OT losses). LW allowing a td & 2 pt conv with :11 left, the Huskies (-21) only beat MAC for Ball St 31-25. Bulls after covering as DD dog & DD Fav, needed a td w/0:03 left to get past Kent St 31-28 (-23). LW UB led Troy 14-0 3Q when former UConn starter/KSU transfer QB Ta'quan Roberson was knocked out of the game. UB led 17-0 4Q but allowed gw td w/:45 left losing 21-17. Roberson is doubtful. Backup QB JC transfer Gunner Gray (6-15-49-0-1 for ssn) finished vs Troy. UB run game (170 ypg, 4.5) faces UConn run Def (149 ypg, 4.0). Both come off 2 straight ATS losses, but we expect UConn's defense vs a backup QB to improve enough to cover here

**NC STATE by 13 over Virginia Tech** - NCSt has won the L/2 mtgs but VT is 6-1 ATS in the series. After an 0-3 start, VT fired HC Brent Pry and former Tulsa HC Phillip Montgomery was named the Interim HC. The Hokies dropped to 0-4 ATS last week, beating Wofford 38-6 (-34'). NCSt dropped to 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS last week, losing at Duke 45-33 (+3). The 'Pack had a 304-149 yd edge but trailed in the 1H. QB Bailey threw 3 int's. NCSt is just 5-11 as a HF since '22. The Wolfpack was the better team last week against Duke but lost. Now they are laying DD's against a team that could see players elect to redshirt after playing 4 games. VT hung with SCar, and led Vandy at half but the loss to ODU was embarrassing and we would rather lay the points with the home chalk here.

**Indiana by 7 over IOWA** - First mtg since '21. Hoosiers have lost 4 straight and 8 of L/99 (3-6 ATS). Last 4 in Iowa City. Indy is 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS. Iowa is 54-15 SU at home the last 11 years. Iowa beat Albany and UMass at home by a 41-7 average, but lost at Iowa St by 3 on a 54-yd FG with no time left. LW QB Gronowski was the first Iowa QB to have 3 rushing TDs in a game since Matt Rodgers in 1990, leading the Hawkeyes past Rutgers, 38-28 (-2). Indiana rolled over their non-conf opp's by a 52-8 average and were 2-1 ATS, only beating ODU 27-14 with 5 failed RZ trips. LW, Indiana blocked a punt for a TD early and Mendoza hit 21-23-267 as Indiana demolished #9 Illinois, 63-10 (-7) with a 579-161 yd edge. Iowa QB Gronowski is hitting 61% with a 3-1 ratio and the D is holding foes to 234 ypg below their avg (#8). Indiana QB Mendoza is hitting 77% with a 14-0 ratio and it is holding foes to 206 ypg below their average (#18). Early line has Indiana -7', so we see it right around there.

**PITTSBURGH by 3 over Louisville** - LTH Pitt was +7, they trailed 21-17 3Q and got td drives of 61 & 36 yds and an 86-yd Pick-6 for a 38-21 upset win. The Panthers started 2-1 and were up 10 4Q vs WVU two weeks ago. Down 7, WV went 87/13 and tied the game with :11 left then Pitt lost in OT, 31-24. UL is 3-0 SU but 0-3 ATS and this is their first game vs a P-4 foe. QB Miller Moss only has a 2-2 ratio and UL Has given up 6 sacks in the L2W. Pitt allows just 84 rush ypg (2.5) and they have 11 sacks. QB Holstein has a 9-3 ratio. The Panthers were missing some key players two weeks ago but had the bye week to heal and we expect AARB Desmond Reid back this week. Pitt is 10-5 as a home dog since '18. UL is 1-7 as road favorites (1-5 under Brohm). The home team is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS and Pitt is 7-1 SU off a bye. Everything points to the underdog Panthers to pull the upset.

**SYRACUSE by 4 over Duke** - Last met in '20. Duke has won 2 of the 3 ACC meetings and the visitor is 3-0 SU/ATS. Syracuse's upset win over Clemson proved costly as QB Angeli, who was the nation's leading passer entering LW is now OFY. LSU transfer RB Ricky Collins is inexperienced so they may rely more on RB Yasin Willis who has 233 (4.5) in 3 games. Duke lost to Illinois and Tulane B2B weeks. Last week they were -3 vs NCSt. The Blue Devils were outgained 304-149 at half but led 21-20 and won 45-33. QB Mensah has thrown for 1,305 w/an 11-2 ratio. DE Vincent Anthony leads the ACC with 5 sacks. Duke is just 18-33 SU on the road while Cuse is 17-5 SU at home yet the Blue Devils are the favorites here. Collins was a highly recruited QB and shouldn't have too much trouble against Duke's #130 ranked pass D (70%, 261 ypg, 5-3). The Orange's only loss was to Tenn and they covered that game, we think they win this outright.

**Georgia Tech by 21 over WAKE FOREST** - GT has won 4 straight meetings and covered the L/2. They last met in '23 and GT won 30-16 (+3). WF is fresh off a bye and two weeks ago played on a Thursday night vs NCSt. They led 14-0 just 7 minutes in but went over 2Q w/o a first down and lost 34-24 (+7). WF's wins are only over Kennesaw St by 1 and Western Carolina. GT is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS. Last week they were -24' and led Temple 45-17 but gave up a td with just :03 left for a backdoor cover and a 'Bad Beat'. GT is +157 ypg on the season. RB's Haynes and Hosley and QB King all have over 200 rush yards. WF RB Demond Claiborne was held to just 12-35 vs NCSt. GT is 10-4 ATS on the road while WF is 0-7 ATS in their last 7 vs FBS teams. Jackets are going into a bye week and they win by 3 td's here.

**CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 3 over Eastern Michigan** - Part of the Michigan MAC Trophy competition (EM, CM & WM). Home team has won 4 straight SU but Eagles have covered last 3. LTH CM (-9') trailed 23-19 into 4Q and held on for a 26-23 win. LY CM (+3') led 34-16 4Q but EM put up 22 unanswered (GW td w/1:42) to not only win 38-34 but also get the miracle front-door cover. CM upset SJSt 16-14 (+13') before being outscored 108-20 (0-2 ATS as 22+ dog) by Pitt & Mich. LW they beat Wagner 49-10 (-30). EM started 0-3 SU & ATS (incl loss vs FCS) but LW upset Louisiana 34-31 (+2) kicking the GW fg w/:03 left. EM has put up at least 23 ppg (incl vs KY) but has allowed almost 40 ppg (incl 28 vs FCS). EM QB Noah Kim is avg 248 ypg (64%, 5-2) while RB Dontae McMillion is avg 7.1 ypc (345 rush). CM has played 4 different QB's. The Chippewas are scoring just 12 ppg vs FBS foes but put up 49 vs FCS & should be able to get some production vs EM's weak D. Still we will take the points and EM here.

**NORTHWESTERN by 10 over Ucla** - Bruins 1st trip to Evanston since '69 (36-0 UCLA win). Last 10 off bye weeks, Bruins are 4-6 SU & 5-5 ATS & 7-2-1 to the over (incl both '24 games). UCLA was 3-0 ATS in road games vs original B10 schools. Cats have lost last 4 SU off bye week, but are 3-1 ATS. Both teams are coming off byes. After going 4-2 ATS at home in '23, NW slipped to 2-5 last year. UCLA did beat both Rutgers and Nebraska on the road last year. Both teams are off to

disappointing starts with Northwestern having -5 TO's vs Tulane in a 23-3 loss and trailed Oregon 34-0 before a couple of late scores for the back-door cover. They did hold the Ducks to 373 yards (196 below avg). QB Preston Stone is hitting 59% with a 3-6 ratio. UCLA was destroyed by Utah in the opener 43-10, then trailed UNLV 23-3 at half in a 30-23 loss. After a 35-10 loss to New Mexico at home, they fired HC Foster. Usually teams get a bounce their first week of an interim HC. The Bruins are allowing 244 rush (5.5) and Nico Iamaleava is hitting 64% with a 3-3 ratio and is the team's leading rusher. Early line has 'Cats -6'. This is a prime spot for David Braun to pick up win #2 this yr. **MINNESOTA by 7 over Rutgers** - Rutgers broke 3-game losing streak to Minnesota LY with 26-19 win. They held Gophers to season-low 35 rush yds. Athan Kaliakmanis hit 17-33-240 vs his old team. LTH in '22, Knights led 31-0 (had 7 FDs & outgained 375-134). Minnesota had a 443-151 yard edge, but only led Buffalo 16-10 in 4Q, winning 23-10. They took on one of the worst FCS teams and led NWSt, 59-0 at half. They lost at Cal 27-14, despite only being outg'd 340-335 with a fumbled PR the key play. Rutgers opened 3-0 SU and 2-1 ATS on the road. LW Rutgers lost to Iowa, 38-28 (+2), falling to 0-5 vs Iowa. QB Kaliakmanis is hitting 69% with a 7-1 ratio but the D is allowing foes 193 ypg above their avg and Minn is holding foes to 203 ypg below their avg. Rutgers is allowing 5.6 ypc rush and Minn is at its best when able to establish the run. They did not have top RB Darius Taylor in the loss to Cal. Minn is 11-6 ATS the last 4 years as a HF and they are fresh off a bye, while Rutgers plays a 5th straight week.

**VANDERBILT by 16 over Utah St** - 1st meeting. Vandy is now 4-0 SU/ATS and ranked #18. They cleared hurdles as underdogs at both VTech and South Carolina. Last week Vandy was -27' and normally Vandy is a poor home favorite but they were out for revenge. They put up 70 points, their most since 1970 and 635 yards. Utah St is also 4-0 ATS. They've already covered against an SEC foe, only losing 44-22 (+33) at Texas A&M. HC Bronco Mendenhall has the offense putting up 37 ppg and 428 ypg. QB Bryson Barnes has an 8-1 ratio. Vandy doesn't have revenge to keep them motivated this time and they have Bama on deck. Bronco Mendenhall is 6-1 ATS as a 20+ underdog and Clark Lea is 3-6 as a HF. Utah St keeps it closer than expected.

**BOISE ST by 20 over App St** - Two winningest G5 programs of the last decade meet for first time since 1994 (Boise St won FCS playoff gm). Broncos getting back on track after losing opener at USF. They've won and covered last 2 with EWU and Air Force, scoring 100 combined pts. They also found their heir to RB Ashton Jeanty in Dylan Riley who scored 5 td's in LW's 49-37 win at AF. Boise's 10-2 ATS L/12 as a home fav. The offense has started to hum but the D allowed 514 yds and 24 fd's to the Falcons. App St comes out of its first bye 2-1 but has lost the last 2 ATS after opening with a 34-11 win over Charlotte (+3). In their last road gm before the break, they outgained USM 470-389 but threw 3 int's incl a 99-yd pick6 and lost in Hattiesburg, 38-22. App St leads the SBC in run D at 62 ypg and 2.1 ypc. Boise on the road, though, is an entirely different assignment. Mountaineers will have some success against the Bronco D, but it won't be enough. They'll get worn down in the 2H by Riley & Co. and fall by 3 td's.

**NEW MEXICO by 7 over New Mexico St** - It's the 115th meeting of the Rio Grande Rivalry. Home tm has lost last 2 and is 1-6 ATS since 2017. UNM (-9') had 579 yds in last year's 50-40 win on the road. Both teams are 2-1 and coming out of a bye wk. The Lobos have been the more impressive tm in HC Jason Eck's first yr. In 2 Big Ten road trips, they covered against Michigan (-35) in a 34-17 loss and shocked UCLA (-15') in the Rose Bowl, 35-10. FCS imports Scottie Humphrey and Damon Bankston already have 200+ yds through 3 gms. NM St opened with home wins over Bryant and Tulsa (-11 ATS) before getting thumped by Louisiana Tech (-10), 49-14, in their first road trip. They allowed 353 rush yds (5.4) which doesn't bode well vs run-first UNM. Aggies are averaging just 18 pts and 1.9 ypc on offense. The Lobos are finding an identity under Eck and are the better squad. But this is a heated instate rivalry, and NM St is 6-1 ATS the last 7 times they were a DD dog in the series. UNM wins but by less than the early Vegas line.

**STANFORD by 3 over San Jose St** - These schools are separated by just 22 miles. Stanford had a 6 game series win streak snapped in last year's finale. SJSt was -2'. The Spartans led 17-10 at half, 27-17 3Q but Stanford went ahead 31-27. SJSt went 37/3 after an int and scored the GW td with 1:52 left. SJSt is 0-9 SU/2-7 ATS at Stanford. The Cardinal are 1-3 SU/ATS and are coming off a 48-20 (+16') loss at Virginia. They gave up season highs of 590 total yards, 206 rush and 384 pass. SJSt lost their home opener to CMich then gave Texas a fight but lost 38-7. They were off a bye last week and only beat FCS Idaho 31-28 (-14). HC Niumatalo is 35-20 as an away dog including 4-1 here but the line is under a fg and Stanford is out for revenge. Our line is Stanford by 3 which doesn't give much betting value.

**SOUTHERN MISS by 7 over Jacksonville St** - Back half of home&home. USM wants payback for last year's 44-7 road loss to Jacksonville St as a 6pt dog. Eagles had 6 TO's and were 1-10 on 3rd downs. But both tms have new coaches and flipped rosters. Charles Huff is 2-2 in his USM debut. Eagles beat App St (-3), 38-22, in Week 3 for the new staff's first key win but lost last week at Louisiana Tech (-3), 30-20. They dug a big early hole and trailed 30-10 at HT, despite outgaining LT 514-340. Charles Kelly is also 2-2 in his first 4 gms at Jax St. Gamecocks opened with covers over UCF and Liberty before dropping last 2 ATS to Ga Southern and Murray St. They're a run-heavy team behind RB Cam Cook (#4 FBS with 537yds) and QB Gavin Wimsatt. USM is better at defending the run than the pass and is allowing 3.6 ypc. They'll stack the box to stop Cook and hand the Gamecocks their 3rd straight road loss to start the season.

**KANSAS by 4 over Cincinnati** - Tms last met in 2023. Kansas (-7) totaled 562 yds and scored 3 td's in final 11:39 of 49-16 road win. Jayhawks (-13) came out of its bye to pound WVU, 41-10, in Big 12 opener for both. They're now 3-0 in their newly renovated stadium and 2-0 ATS at home vs FBS opp (HC Leipold 17-10-1 ATS at home here). KU's only loss came at Missouri in Week 3 in a gm they led late in the 4Q. At home, the Jayhawks are averaging 245 rush ypg and 6.0 ypc. Cincinnati is coming out of its first bye. They reached the off week 2-1 SU & ATS, losing to Nebraska (-6'), 20-17, in the opener before beating Bowling Green (+23'), 34-20, and NW St (+48'), 70-0. The D has yet to allow more than 20pts in a gm and is #18 in the FBS at 4.1 ypg. This is Cincy's first true road gm but they're 4-1 SU & ATS in road openers. These teams are near equals, but KU is playing great at home. Jayhawks grab a 4pt win in their toughest gm since facing Missouri.

**WASHINGTON (+) over Ohio St** - First mtg s/19 (OSU won Rose Bowl 28-23) & OSU's 1st trip to Seattle since 2007. Huskies host the Buckeyes the week after their Apple Cup rivalry vs Wash St. Washington is 8-1 SU at home under Fisch. Washington opened 2-0 SU/ATS and has an exciting QB in Demond Williams, RB in Jonah Coleman and top WR Denzel Boston plus a couple of 6'4" CB's to combat the Ohio St talented WR's. Last week, Washington scored on every possession, extending its season opening scoring streak to 21 straight drives, for a 59-24 win (-20') with 473-305 yd edge, getting revenge for LY's Apple Cup loss. Ohio St was outgained by Texas 336-203 in its season opening win, then walloped Grambling St and Ohio at home before taking last weekend off. Young QB's usually struggle in their first road start, and this is Julian Sayin's first road start. Huskies are getting over a td here and while we won't call for an upset, we do think the home dog keeps it close!

**NAVY by 10 over Rice** - These two met last year under different circumstances and Rice pulled the upset, 24-10 (+11'). Rice has a new HC in Scott Abell who runs the triple option. The Owls are 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS and they've pulled road upsets over both Louisiana and Charlotte. Navy is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS. The Middies are #1 in the FBS, avg 375 rush ypg. Rice is avg 246 (4.6). Navy only allows 82 (3.0) and Rice allows 133 (4.0). We don't see Rice pulling a 3rd road upset but they are getting just over 2 td's and much like the Military Academy games, we figure this will be a low scoring, closer than expected game.

**Baylor by 31 over OKLAHOMA ST** - Baylor had lost 11 straight in Stillwater, but has split last 4 trips. Bears won at home LY, 38-28, as a 7 pt fav. They had 565 yds and got the cover on a td with 3:06 left. Baylor 2-2 SU & ATS and looking to rebound from LW's crushing home loss to Arizona St, 27-24, on a walk-off fg. The offense, which was so potent the first 3 wks, produced a ssn-low 357 yds. Bears need to get back on track quickly and have the right option to get it done. After going 3-9 last yr, all signs point to Oklahoma St being worse in 2025. Since beating UT Martin, Cowboys have lost to Oregon and Tulsa by a combined score of 88-15, are 0-3 ATS and just canned longtime HC Mike Gundy. Against Tulsa (+11') they were 4-15 on 3rd downs and didn't reach the EZ until the 4Q. OSU lacks the firepower and direction to keep pace with QB Sawyer Robertson and his weapons. The Bears will take out their frustrations on an outmanned opponent and roll to a blowout road win.

**SOUTH CAROLINA by 9 over Kentucky** - SC is 3-0 SU/ATS vs KY. Last year the Gamecocks were -9', they held KY to 183 yards and won 31-6. Gamecocks are off B2B losses to Vandy and Mizzou. QB Sellers returned from injury last week. SC had -9 rush yards and Sellers was sacked 5 times yet they still covered as 10 point dogs, losing 29-20. KY is fresh off a bye. They are 2-1 with wins over MAC foes Toledo & EMich. Their lone loss was at home against Ole Miss. This is QB Cutter Boley's first career road start. Boley is hitting just 54% but does have a 2-0 ratio. Both RB's McGowan and Dowdell have topped 200 rush this year. The 'Cats D is allowing 415 ypg and they allowed EMich to put up 461 including 330 passing. SC's D is holding foes 129 ypg below their avg. 9 of the last 10 have gone Under so this could be another low scoring game. Look for DE Dylan Stewart to harass QB Boley into mistakes. KY is 33-19-1 as underdogs s/16 while SC is 14-9 as HF. We are riding with the Chalk here, SC by over a td.

**NORTH TEXAS by 17 over South Alabama** - Mean Green (+6) rolled, 52-38, on the road last yr. UNT trailed at HT and was outgained 582-550 but rallied for the win with 38 2H pts. Mean Green is 4-0 and 3-1 ATS, with all 3 vs FBS opponents going over total. In 2 home gms, they outscored Lamar and Washington St by 110-10 combined. The D leads the FBS in takeaways and the American in pass D (122 pass ypg). South Alabama has played better than its 1-3 record. Jags covered vs Tulane and Auburn, and were +126 yds last Saturday against Coastal Carolina. However, they were -3 in TO's and lost to the Chanticleers (+14'), 38-20, in their worst effort of the year. USA fumbled the ball 5 times (lost 1), and that kind of sloppiness will be particularly costly against the ball-hawking Mean Green. UNT will win the TO battle, convert takeaways into points, and coast to another DD home win.

**KANSAS ST by 10 over Ucf** - KSU leads series 2-0. LTH in 2023, Wildcats (-4') had 536 yds in 44-31 win. KSU has been one of the biggest disappointments so far, starting 1-3 and 0-4 ATS. Before LW's bye, they fell to Arizona in a loss more one-sided than the score indicates (-219 yds and just 8 fd's). But the bye came at a good time. The Cats needed to reboot and get healthy, especially RB Dylan Edwards who's had just 4 carries all ssn and is an essential part of the offense. Under HC Klicman, KSU is 14-7 ATS as a HF incl 2 losses this month. Everyone is about to get a better read on UCF. The Knights are 3-0 but unlike KSU they have yet to face a quality opponent. They beat Jax St (+20') by only 7, hammered NC A&T, and LW outclassed North Carolina, 34-9, obliterating our Sept 5★. Now they have their first road trip to play a rested KSU team facing a crossroad in the ssn. Cats are better than their start and will show it by handing overrated UCF its first loss of the year.

**OLE MISS by 6 over Lsu** - Ole Miss is out for legit revenge. The Rebels allowed a td with :32 left and LSU won 29-26 in OT. Rebels are 4-0 SU/2-2 ATS this year. QB Trinidad Chambliss took over for inj'd starter QB Simmons against Ark. He threw for 353 and 1 td, rushed for 62 and they won 41-35 (-6'). LW Chambliss started vs Tulane. He threw for 307 and rushed for 112. LSU is 4-0 but hasn't looked the part since beating Clemson who has dropped 2 games since. LSU only put up 23 points vs LA Tech, was outgained by Florida (5 int's) and LW had a slow start before pulling away in the 2Q vs SELA. The home team is 11-1 ATS with 7 straight covers. QB Chambliss has been impressive so far. LSU's D is allowing just 246 ypg and holding foes 109 ypg below their avg but their offense is only putting up 11 ypg more than their foes allow. Series history favors the home team and that's the route we are going, plus there's the revenge factor. Hotty Toddy!

**Tulane by 17 over TULSA** - Tulane trails the all-time series 13-7 but they are 5-2 SU since '17 (4-2-1 ATS). They last met in '23 in New Orleans. Tulane was struggling to get distance on teams that year and they only won 24-22 (-24). The Green Wave started 3-0 SU but were no match for Ole Miss in a 45-10 loss, outgained 548-282. Tulsa gets extra rest to celebrate their first win over Oklahoma St since 1998 which ultimately led to Mike Gundy's firing. Hurricane HC Tre Lamb is 8-3 as a DD Dog going back to his time in the FCS at Gardner-Webb and ETSU. Jon Sumrall is 10-2-1 ATS as an AF! The angles cancel each other out. Tulane was dominant prior to last week and they are playing back at their level while Tulsa is off a fairly historic win. Tulane is the better team, so lay the points.

**LOUISIANA by 7 over Marshall** - Massive revenge spot for LA and HC Desormeaux who lost SBC title gm LY in Lafayette, 31-3. Playing without their QB, Cajuns were held to season-lows pts, yds and fd's in loss to Marshall. Louisiana won't have their starting QB for this one either. RFR Daniel Beale has been under center since (50.7%, 1-2 ratio). The offense has missed Howard, ranking #130 in yds below opposing defense's average. Cajuns fell to 1-3 with LW's loss to EMU (+2') and are 0-3 ATS vs FBS opp. Marshall has rebounded from an 0-2 start to win b2b gms vs EKU and MTSU (2-0 ATS). Herd played their best gm against MTSU, winning 42-28, as 3pt favorite. They trailed 28-21 at the start of the 4Q before scoring 3 unanswered td's behind the passing of Carlos Del Rio-Wilson (18-22-261-4-0). After 2 wks on the road, Louisiana is happy to be back home. Cajuns will ride the legs of RB's Zylan Perry and Bill Davis to a close home win and a measure of revengs for LY's embarrassing CG loss.

**Arkansas St by 3 over ULM** - Since 2010, Arkansas St is 15-0 SU/15-0 ATS vs ULM, with 11 of the wins coming by DD! ASU is mired in a 3-gm skid since beating SEMO in the opener. They covered

at home vs Iowa St (-21) in a respectable 24-16 loss but followed it up by falling LW at Kennesaw St, 28-21 (-4'). The offense is missing the production of star WR Corey Rucker and the D is 132nd in ypp allowed (7.2). ULM is coming off its best gm, beating UTEP in El Paso, 31-25, as a 6pt dog. Warhawks were -43 yds but used 2 int's and 250 yds rushing to build a big lead and hold on for a 2-1 start. While ULM has more momentum following the road win at UTEP, this is the kind of extended series streak you never want to get in front of. The Red Wolves will find a way to maintain its dominance of ULM, getting out of Monroe with a 3-pt victory.

**MISSOURI by 52 over UMass** - LY despite neither team scoring in 4Q #21 Mizzou (-27'), on the road, covered with a 45-3 win despite being in A&M/Auburn sandwich. This year Mizzou has a bye on deck. The Minutemen are 0-3 SU/ATS including a 27-26 loss (-15) to FCS Bryant. While they are off a Bye they have their MAC opener on deck, which is a much more winnable game vs WM. Missouri is 4-0 SU & 3-1 ATS with their only ATS loss LW as they only beat South Carolina 29-20 (-10). Tigers are avg 46 ppg and have shown no mercy vs overmatched teams beating Central Arkansas 61-6 & Louisiana 52-10. Tigers are 11-4 ATS in non-conf games laying 30+ pts s/2009. UMass just needs to get out healthy for conference play, while Missouri can play for style points and show no mercy (scored 53 pts in 4Q).

**KENNESAW ST by 3 over Middle Tennessee** - KSU covered their first mtg LY, losing 14-5 (+9'). We really respect the job Jerry Mack has done with KSU. They started 0-2 but nearly upset WF, lost 10-9. Now they've won 2 straight including a 28-21 win over Arkansas St where they had a 497-318 yd edge. MT appeared to have turned things around after their season opening loss to Austin Peay. They were close at the half vs Wisky then won at Nevada. Last week MT led Marshall 28-21 start of 4Q but Marshall scored the final 3 td's and won by 14. KSU is just 1-9 ATS as a favorite and they are laying 7 points here. Mason is 4-12 ATS at MT but they catch KSU in a rare role and we think they keep it close.

**Western Kentucky by 14 over MISSOURI ST** - This is Missouri St's first ever CUSA game. The Bears are 2-2 with expected losses to USC and SMU. They rallied to beat Marshall 21-20 and last week they crushed UT Martin 42-10. All 3 of WKU's wins are by double-digits including last week, 31-16 (-9) over Nevada. Toppers QB Maverick McIvor has thrown for 1,157 w/a 10-2 ratio. Missouri St's pass D is #106 (220 ypg, 71%, 4-3). Bears QB Jacob Clark has a 10-5 ratio but faces WKU's pass D that is #25 (170 ypg, 52%, 3-4). WKU is laying 5' which seems cheap as they face one of the best teams in their new conference. Toppers by 2 td's.

**COLORADO ST by 3 over Washington St** - WSU have won last 2 by a combined 88-31 (2-0 ATS). CSU which their MWC opener on deck while WSU has a bye on deck. Both have faced Washington Ty. CSU (+21) opened the season at Washington & were tied 21-21 3Q. CSU allowed 17 to lose 38-21 (+21'). LW WSU hosted a Washington team looking for revenge from a '24 loss. WSU (+20') only rallied 31-24 4Q before allowing L/28 including a 47 yd IR td & 59 yd td pass with 2:40 left. Cougars are 2-2 SU & 1-3 ATS but their only cover was a 36-13 (-1') win over MWC foe SDSt, which beat Cal 34-0 LW. LW CSU almost pulled out the outright upset. Down 17-10 (+4') they scored a td w/:29 left but went for the win but failed (2 pt NG). With very similar seasons (both just got by FCS foe) we will take the points here.

**PENN ST by 7 over Oregon** - Rematch of LY's B10 Title game won by Oregon 45-37. In road games vs ranked opponents since '14, Ducks are 11-5 ATS (4 games vs ranked teams last year were home/neutral site). Nittany Lions never led last year, but their 518 offensive yards were most allowed by Ducks in '24. Penn St has covered 3 straight off bye weeks and Oregon is playing for a 5th straight week. Penn St is 61-11 SU at home the last 11 years. Penn St played 3 weak foes to open and won by an average of 44-6, but were 0-3 ATS allowing two back-door TDs. Oregon blew out two teams at home by a 64-8 margin, including OKSt, then allowed a back-door to NW, 34-14. Last week, Oregon defeated in-state rival Oregon St, 41-7 (-33') with a 585-147 yd edge. Penn St is playing with revenge, are fresh off a bye and has a good situation and more returning talent. Plus, this will be a White Out for Penn St. Early line has Penn St -3 and we call for the Nittany Lions to cover.

**Alabama by 3 over GEORGIA** - Bama owns this series with a 9-1 SU/6-4 ATS record and they've won & covered 3 straight. Last year Bama was up 30-7 at half w/a 343-178 yd edge. Georgia stormed back to take a 34-33 lead but it didn't last long as Ryan Williams 75 yd td catch put Bama back up for good. Both teams are fresh off a bye. Bama has been on a mission since losing the opener. They crushed ULM 73-0 (-35) then beat Wisconsin 38-14 (-20) w/a 454-209 yd edge. UGA was underwhelming in their first two games and trailed Tenn 21-7 3Q but won the game in OT. Gunner Stockton threw for 304 yards and he has a 4-0 ratio. UGA gave up 4 td passes vs the Vols and now face Ty Simpson who is hitting 72% w/a 9-0 ratio and WR's Gernie Bernard and Ryan Williams. UGA's defense has given up over 300 passing yards in 5 of their last 9 SEC games. The Dawgs have won 33 straight home games but Bama has been more impressive since losing their opener and we are calling for the outright upset.

**Louisiana Tech by 10 over UTEP** - LA Tech is 11-1 SU/6-5 ATS in this series since '13. They've won 7 of their L/8 trips to El Paso (5-3 ATS). LA Tech's 30-20 (-3) win over SMiss is misleading. They led 30-10 at half and put the offense away in the 2nd half. After scoring just 31 points and putting up 416 yards in their first two games, LT switched to QB Blake Baker and they put up 49 pts/574 yds vs NMSU and 30 pts/340 yds vs SMiss. UTEP is 1-3 SU/ATS and their only win came against FCS UT Martin. The Miners gave Texas a better game than expected but lost to both Utah St and ULM. QB Malachi Nelson has an 8-5 ratio. LT's 3 covers have been by 17.6 ppg but it's hard to give a strong lean considering they are 2-18 SU on the road and 0-8 ATS as road chalk. We side with the Bulldogs but not a strong lean.

**Brigham Young by 10 over COLORADO** - Rematch of last year's Alamo Bowl won by BYU (+3'), 36-14. Cougars held Colorado to ssn-low 210 yds and taunted Deion Sanders, so the coach has had this one circled for a while. BYU is off to a terrific start, despite turning the offense over to frosh QB Bear Bachmeier after veteran Jake Retzlaff transferred in the summer. The D has allowed 16 pts in 3 gms, all wins and covers, and leads the FBS with 3.5 ypp allowed. The offense leans on RB LJ Martin (342, 8.6) and has not had to ask Bachmeier to do too much. Colorado is 2-2 and coming off its best gm of the ssn, a 37-20 win over Wyoming (+13). It was their first cover and their best offensive showing. Buffs' revolving door at QB has stopped for now after Kaidon Salter accounted for 390 yds and 4 td's. Under Sanders, Colorado is 10-4-1 ATS in Boulder. However, Buffs are 0-2 ATS vs P4 tms this yr, and BYU will make it 0-3 with another stifling defensive effort and just enough on offense to earn a 10pt road win.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ Washington over ATLANTA** - The trend stack points hard to WAS: 4-0 SU/ATS H2H vs ATL, ATL just 1-4 SU/ATS as a home dog, 1-9 SU (0-10 ATS) after back-to-back unders, and 0-8 SU/ATS when the opponent hits 10+ points (WAS avgs almost 4 TDs PG). WAS QB Jayden Daniels (knee sprain, possible PCL) is questionable—ruled out last wk, limited in practice, and “day-to-day” per Dan Quinn; Marcus Mariota starts if Daniels can’t go. Mariota showed the offense is still plenty functional, keeping WAS on schedule and threatening downfield, while ATL’s offense is on the struggle bus and their totals profile keeps lining up poorly against competent scoring teams. With ATL avg 14 PPG #31 vs WAS 26.7 PPG #7 this one points to a clear mismatch. **FORECAST: Washington by 13**

**3★ LA RAMS over Indianapolis** - IND’s offense has traveled, with Daniel Jones at 316 pass yds and Jonathan Taylor at 165 rush yds LW, but this is a B2B road spot (IND 1-3 SU/ATS in that scenario) and WR Alec Pierce (concussion protocol) is uncertain, which could narrow spacing for Pittman/Downs. H2H the last 7 years leans LAR (IND 0-2 SU, 1-1 ATS), and the Rams have been reliable laying points (6-0 SU, 5-1 ATS) and at home as favorites (3-1 SU; Under 4-0). Stafford is in rhythm (298-2-0 LW) with Adams/Nacua cooking, the rush just posted 5 sacks, and even after that blocked-kick heartbreak, LAR’s overall profile plus SoFi advantage points to the Rams finishing stronger late. **FORECAST: LA Rams by 10**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ NEW ENGLAND over Carolina** - NE was efficient LW (Drake Maye 19/23, 230, 2 TD) and special teams swung it (Antonio Gibson 98-yd KOR TD), and they hold a yards edge (346 YPG vs 277). Spot/trends back the Pats: NE as a -3.5+ home fav is 2-1 SU/ATS since ‘22 and they took the lone H2H in the last 7 yrs 24-6. CAR just hit 30 LW, but they’re 0-10 SU/ATS the next game after scoring 27+, and injuries are stacking up (TE Ja’Vion Sanders ankle/foot; recent OL dings). With those edges and NE’s defense tightening late, expect the Pats to control field position, stack red-zone points, and pull clear after halftime. **FORECAST: New England by 14**

## OTHER PLAYS

**Seattle vs ARIZONA** — TNF - SEA is 7-0 SU / 6-1 ATS vs ARI and 7-0 SU / 5-2 ATS on the road, while ARI is 6-1 SU / 5-2 ATS at home. Totals snapshot: last four in the series are 3-1 Under; ARI home totals are 4-0 Over. SEA QB Darnold went 21/31, 235, 2-0 vs ARI LW with MIN; ARI turns to Benson with Conner (ankle, IR) out, and SEA monitors Charbonnet (foot). Side trends tilt SEA, but ARI’s home cover make it interesting.

**Pittsburgh by 3 over Minnesota**— Ireland game at Croke Park, early Sunday morning: MIN leaned on its defense last week (kept the opponent out of the end zone, 0/3 in the red zone, 212 total yards allowed) while RB Jason “Mighty” Mason ripped 15-108 (7.2 per carry) and Carson Wentz stayed efficient to keep the chains moving. That blueprint gets tougher on a neutral field against a PIT unit that just forced 5 turnovers, and Aaron Rodgers added 2 TDs to finish the job. With Rodgers’ long history seeing MIN looks and the Vikings likely needing more than a run-led script overseas, we’ll back PIT to edge a tight one.

**HOUSTON by 14 over Tennessee** — HOU has controlled this matchup (4-1 SU/ATS H2H) and fits several angles: home favorites are 5-2 SU (2-5 ATS) with a strong Under run (9-1), while TEN as an away dog is 1-7 SU / 2-6 ATS with totals 7-2 Over. On the field, HOU’s defense has traveled—4 sacks vs TB and no giveaways—while C.J. Stroud (207-1-0 LW) and Nick Chubb (25-yd TD) provided enough punch despite red-zone stalls (360-266 yard deficit vs TB). TEN’s offense has sputtered (279 total yds vs LAR after 133 at DEN to open), with rookie QB Cam Ward absorbing 11 sacks across two weeks and an OL still banged up (RT JC Latham knee, RG Kevin Zeitler elbow). Situationally, HOU is 4-1 SU/ATS after back-to-back losses, and both 2024 meetings between these clubs went Over—useful context alongside the side trends pointing toward HOU.

**BUFFALO by 20 over New Orleans** — BUF checks the boxes: 1-0 SU/ATS H2H in the last 7 years (the older 5-1 SU/ATS NO run was the Brees era), perfect 3-0 SU/ATS on B2B home games LY, and NO is 1-5 SU/ATS on B2B road spots with a 1-8 SU / 2-7 ATS mark after back-to-back losses LY. The number is big—BUF as a -10.5+ home favorite is 5-0 SU (0-5 ATS)—but the on-field edge has shown up: vs NYJ, BUF’s defense held the Jets to 154 total yards while James Cook (132 rush, 2 TD) paced a balanced attack. NO just dropped another road game at SEA, and recurring issues with protection/penalties in high-leverage spots are a tough fit at Highmark against a defense that has been efficient on early downs.

**KANSAS CITY by 3 over Baltimore** — BAL comes in on a short week off the DET beatdown where Lamar was sacked 7 times and the offense never settled, while KC returns to Arrowhead with the recent edge in this matchup (KC 3-1 SU/ATS vs BAL). Trend notes cut both ways: BAL is 5-1 SU/ATS after scoring 30+, but the Ravens are on a 0-2 SU/ATS slide as a road favorite. With KC 316 YPG vs BAL 331 YPG and the Mahomes-Kelce timing typically sharper at home, expect a tight, possession game where the home side squeezes it out late.

**TAMPA BAY by 3 over Philadelphia** — H2H leans TB 3-1 SU/ATS, and TB has been a profitable home dog in this matchup the last two years (2-0 SU/ATS vs PHI, including 33-16 LY). TB also fits a favorable angle: off back-to-back wins now catching points (3-1 SU/ATS), while PHI counters with a strong 4-1 SU/ATS record as an away favorite. On-field, TB just posted a 360-266 yard edge at HOU (Mayfield 215-2-0, late Rachaad White TD) with the defense permitting only one offensive TD and registering 4 sacks; monitor TB WR Mike Evans (hamstring) and a potential Chris Godwin return. Note PHI’s ATS last week hinged on a blocked-kick TD as time expired. With TB’s recent series success and live home-dog trend vs PHI, this profiles as a tight, numbers-driven spot for the home side.

**Los Angeles by 7 over NEW YORK GIANTS** — Context leans LAC: away favorite 4-1 SU/ATS, plus 5-2 SU (6-1 ATS) on the road overall, while NYG at home are 1-9 SU (3-7 ATS) TY/LY and as home dogs under +7 sit 0-8 SU (2-6 ATS) with the Under 7-1. H2H is light recently (one meeting in the last 7 years), but that was a comfortable LAC win (37-21 in 2021) and the broader series run is 5-0 SU/ATS (with the caveat most were 2005-2013). On-field, LAC just played clean, efficient ball (no punts, Herbert 19/27 for 242 and 2 TD) while the defense stacked 3 INT and 3 sacks; Quentin Johnston flashed with a 60-yard score. NYG pivot to rookie QB Dart after Wilson’s benching—there’s always “new starter” pop, but it meets a Chargers road trend that’s traveled and a defense coming off a takeaway game. NYG’s recent home and short-dog splits remain the sticking points here.

**Chicago by 7 over LAS VEGAS** — CHI comes in off a crisp 31-14 win, with Caleb Williams tossing 4 TDs as the offense balanced efficiency and red-zone finishing while the defense tightened when it mattered. LV just gave up 41 at WSH, including a pick-six and multiple ex-

plosives, as the Raiders’ defense struggled to get off the field against Marcus Mariota (15/21, 206 yds, 2 total TD). H2H favors CHI 2-0 SU/ATS with decisive margins (30-12, 20-9), and LV is 0-5 ATS after allowing 40+. With CHI’s passing rhythm trending up and LV’s coverage/leverage issues lingering, the matchup metrics lean Bears.

**Jacksonville by 1 over SAN FRANCISCO** — Series leans SF (last 7 yrs: SF 2-0 SU/ATS; 6-0 ATS vs JAX since ‘05), but the spot trends tilt toward JAX: SF is 1-3 SU (0-4 ATS) after back-to-back wins and 3-2 SU (1-4 ATS) in B2B home games, including a 1-point escape LW that missed the number. Production is essentially even (JAX 356.3 YPG vs SF 361.0), and QB health in SF remains a watch item (Purdy day-to-day; Mac Jones aggravated a knee), which could curb SF’s chunk plays. If JAX keeps explosives in check and stays even in yardage, the Jags have a live path to upset it in Santa Clara despite the historical headwinds.

**Detroit by 10 over CLEVELAND** — CLE’s defense stubbornly kept GB to 10 last week and the ground game showed life with CLE rookie RB Q. Judkins posting 18-94-1, but the offense still sputtered for long stretches. DET rolls in off a statement over BAL (38-30) where DET RB D. Montgomery ripped 12-151-2 and the pass game stayed efficient (DET WR A. St. Brown 7-77-1), a surge that matches the trend: after scoring 35+, DET is 10-0 SU (9-1 ATS). Spot/trends lean home side too: CLE as a +7 or more RD is 0-4 SU (1-3 ATS), while DET has handled the bigger favorite role at Ford. Expect CLE’s D and Judkins to keep it tight early, but DET’s balanced punch and recent momentum point to a late pull-away.

**Green Bay vs DALLAS** - SNF - GB has owned the recent H2H (5-0 SU/ATS, 2-0 in the Love era) and is 2-0 SU/ATS in B2B road spots the past three years; even so, the Pack comes in off a 13-10 loss where they led 10-0 before stalling (J. Love 183-1). DAL just took a 31-14 defeat at CHI, but there were usable pieces: D. Prescott went 251-1, TE J. Ferguson vacuumed 13-82 to move chains, and the run game popped (J. Williams 10-76, 7.6 per). Trend-wise, DAL as a home dog of +3.5+ is 1-5 SU (2-4 ATS), but primetime at home plus a capable front gives them a path. Meanwhile GB’s pass rush is bringing back EDGE Parsons to hunt Dak and add to his 1.5 sacks this year.

**New York Jets vs MIAMI DOLPHINS** — MNF — Recent H2H leans MIA (4-1 SU, 3-2 ATS). MIA returns home off TNF (lost 21-31 at BUF: Tua 146-2, Achane 12-62, Hill 5-49-1) with the trend note that MIA after Thursday is 2-2 SU (1-3 ATS). NYJ narrowly fell 27-29 at TB (Tyrod 197-2 passing plus 48 rush; Garrett Wilson 10-84-1) and are 0-4 SU/ATS off a loss by ≤3. Some push for the home team: MIA as a home favorite is 3-1 SU (2-2 ATS), while NYJ as a road dog is 0-4 SU (2-2 ATS) and on B2B road-dog spots are 1-3 SU (2-2 ATS). HC Glenn and NYJ will try to dance their way to a win while HC McDaniel will try to stay alive in Miami.

**Cincinnati Bengals vs DENVER BRONCOS** — MNF — Trend tug-of-war here: DEN as a home favorite is 8-0 SU (7-1 ATS), the lone miss a bad beat vs TEN earlier this year), while CIN has handled this role well as a road dog of >4 (4-3 SU, 6-1 ATS) and is 2-1 SU/ATS on B2B road spots (LY). H2H leans CIN recently (2-0 SU/ATS last 6 yrs). Context matters: DEN is 5-0 SU/ATS after B2B losses, and the pass rush has flashed at altitude; CIN just came off a 40+ against but historically responds at the window (3-4 SU, 6-1 ATS next game). With Joe Burrow still out, CIN rides Jake Browning’s timing with Ja’Marr Chase (big volume since taking over), whereas DEN’s Bo Nix has shown efficiency despite late-game miscues. Numbers point to a tight MNF at Mile High with strong home-favorite trends meeting a proven Bengals road-dog cover profile.
