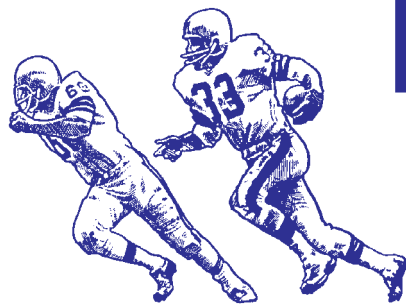

4★ ALABAMA over Vanderbilt - Bama is out for revenge after losing to Vandy last year. The situation was all set up for Bama to lose that game. They were off a win over Georgia. Vandy had just lost to Georgia St. While Bama is once again off a win over Georgia, Vandy is 5-0 this year and ranked #16. Vandy's D allowed 35 points and 393 yards last week against Utah St. Bama's D has held all 4 foes to their season low yards, and are holding foes 204 ypg below their avg (#3 in FBS). Bama has taken on our #4 sked while Vandy has only faced our #95 sked. There's no overlooming Vandy this time and Bama is 24-9-1 ATS as a HF since '20. We won with Bama a few weeks ago when they smoked Wisconsin 38-14 and we will go back to the Tide here for our top Newsletter play!

FORECAST: ALABAMA by 21

3★ APPALACHIAN ST over Oregon St - First meeting. App St returns to Boone sitting at 2-2 after b2b road losses to Southern Miss and Boise St. They outgained USM but gave up a costly pick-6 and were -2 TO's. In fact, they're -8 TO's over the last 3 gms so taking better care of the ball is a must. Oregon St is 0-5 and last wk's 27-24 OT loss to Houston (-12) was the Beavers' first cover of 2025. They outgained the unbeaten Cougars 390-352 and led 24-10 in the 4Q but could not hold the lead. Now, after an emotional loss and the season slowly slipping away, OSU must travel 2,600 miles for their longest road trip of the yr. In their first two road trips to Oregon and Texas Tech, Beavers were dominated on both sides and lost by a combined score of 86-21. App St, on the other hand, is 53-9 at home the last 10 years and has covered the last 4 times they were home dogs (3 outright upsets). With more at stake, Mountaineers outscore fading OSU by 7.

FORECAST: APPALACHIAN ST by 7

3★ Iowa St over Cincinnati - Under HC Satterfield, Cincinnati is 0-2 SU & ATS vs Iowa St. Bearcats (+7) lost LY in Ames, 34-17, and fell, 30-10, at home in 2023 as a 5pt fav. Both gms went under total and in '23 Cincy had ssn-low 214 yds. Both tms are coming off solid wins and are 2 of the remaining 6 Big 12 tms without a conference loss. Iowa St is 5-0 and was never threatened by Arizona (+5). Cyclones failed to cover their only true road gm, beating Ark St, 24-16, as a 21pt fav. Cincinnati has won 3 straight since losing the opener to Nebraska, 20-17. LW they went into Lawrence and handed Kansas (-4') its first home loss of the yr, 37-34. The offense churned out 603 yds incl 215 rushing and 388 from QB Brendan Sorsby. But the defense allowed 597 tot yds and 445 through the air. Iowa St has the coaching edge and has shut down the Bearcat offense the last 2 yrs. We won our top Newsletter play on the Cyclones last week and we are going back for more!

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ VIRGINIA TECH over Wake Forest - The home team is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series. They last met in '23 when VT won 30-13 (-1') at home. They are back in Blacksburg after a road trip to NCSt where the Hokies season turned around. VT played SC even in the opener but gave up 2 big plays, led Vandy 20-10 at half then played 6 horrific quarters of football that ultimately cost Brent Pry his job. Last week they were +10' at NCSt. RB Stewart was 15-174 and VT finished w/4 406-299 yd edge as the Hokies won 23-21. WF lost at home to that same NCSt team 34-24 two weeks ago. They did nearly upset GTech last week, losing 30-29 (+14) in OT. QB Ashford has a 1-3 ratio. RB Claiborne had 119 rush but VT's D just held NCSt to 59 rush yds. Hokies have ply'd the tougher sked (#41 vs #102). VT's 3 losses were all non-conf so they have everything to play for. VT is laying under a td and we think the Hokies are a play-on team now.

FORECAST: VIRGINIA TECH by 17

2★ ARIZONA over Oklahoma St - Home tm has won 6 str in series but schools last met in '12. Both are coming off losses. Arizona fell for the first time, losing their road opener at Iowa St (-5'), 39-14. They were only -39 yds so the gm was not as one-sided as the score indicates. Despite the loss, we remain high on the Wildcats, espec in Tucson, where they handled their first 3 opp's and went 3-0 ATS. QB Noah Fifita is having a rebound ssn (8-2 ratio) and the D is underrated. Arizona is #4 in pass eff D and is one of just 2 tms yet to allow td pass (0-6 ratio!). Okla St is on its way to being this yr's worst Big 12 tm. They've lost 3 str incl a 66pt loss to Oregon and a loss to Tulsa as a 9pt fav. Cowboys did cover in LW's 45-27 loss to Baylor (-21) but were outgained 612-448. OSU got a bump in the first gm with an interim staff but now must hit the road against a motivated opp. This one could get out of control fast, with Arizona pounding overmatched OSU by 4 td's.

Sam Houston at NEW MEXICO ST - Home team has won & covered both games in this series. SH won last year 31-11 (-16') w/4 382-152 yd edge. LTH NMSt was -3' and won 27-13. SH is 0-4 SU/ATS this year, -27 ppg and -215 ypg yet they are -2'. NMSt is 2-2 SU/1-3 ATS. Last week NMSt led rival New Mexico 17-14 at half. They trailed 24-20 4Q then allowed 75 & 38 yd td drives and lost the cover as 16 pt dogs. This is already SH's 4th road game. NMSt is rushing for just 40 ypg (1.5). SH gives up 322 pass ypg (#130 pass D). NMSt is 4-2 ATS as a home dog. Call 1-800-654-3448 or go to NCSports.com to get our Thursday College Marquee for \$15.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 3rd

USF by 30 over Charlotte - USF crushed CLT in the previous two meetings, winning 59-24 (-2') last year and 48-10 (-7) in '23. Both teams are fresh off a bye. USF is 3-1 SU/ATS with wins over Boise St and at Florida. CLT is 1-3 SU/ATS and their only win was over FCS Monmouth. The Bulls are putting up 32 ppg/400 ypg and avg 100 ypg more than their foes allow. They've put up the most yards that both Florida and Miami, FL allowed. Charlotte is allowing 29 ppg/425 ypg and they are giving up 104 ypg more than their foes avg. USF has the edge in all 3 phases and they've cleared this year's 27 point spread in each of the last two meetings so we have a small lean on the home team.

Western Kentucky by 3 over DELAWARE - This is Delaware's first CUSA home game and they've won 10 straight at Delaware Stadium. WKU just beat CUSA's other new addition, Missouri ST 27-22 (-3'). The 'Toppers trailed 16-10 3Q then scored the next 17 points. They stopped MSU's 2 pt conv to get the cover. Delaware is off to a strong start as an FBS member. They are 3-1 SU/ATS with wins over UConn and FIU. The Blue Hens are +36 ypg and QB Nick Minicucci has an 8-2 ratio. WKU's QB McIvor has an 11-2 ratio and Delaware is only #94 in our pass D rankings (64%, 5-4). Delaware's pass D will be tested this week and we like the 'Toppers to win a close game.

SAN JOSE ST by 3 over New Mexico - SJ St has owned this series recently. Spartans have covered 7 str and have won last 6 at home. LTH in 2020, SJ St (-13') won 38-21. However, these tms got off to different starts in Sept. UNM has surprised for new HC Jason Eck. Lobos 3-1, which means they could be playing for their first bowl since 2016. They're 3-0 ATS vs FBS tms including covering vs Michigan, stunning UCLA, and LW's 38-20 win over rival NM St (+172 yds). UNM has already covered at the Big House and Rose Bowl, so they won't be unnerved by this trip. Spartans fell to 1-3 with last wk's 30-29 loss to Stanford (-3). They had 524yds and led 4Q but allowed GW to w/19 sec left. SJ St 2-0 ATS on road & 0-2 ATS at home. We like UNM's balance with a deep backfield and QB Jack Layne who threw 4 td passes LW and now faces a vulnerable secondary. SJ St really needs this gm and maintains its series domination with 3pt win.

BYU by 25 over West Virginia - West Virginia has won both prior mtgs but this is their first-ever trip to Provo. Since beating rival Pitt in Week 3, the Mountaineers have come back to earth with blowout losses to Kansas and Utah. They're 1-3 ATS vs FBS tms incl a SU loss to Ohio, and the offense is

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15th in Big 12 scoring (22ppg) and 14th in ypp (5.6). Rich Rod doesn't have a QB he can rely on which is particular problem this week against BYU. Cougars are 4-0 led by Big 12 top defense (9.3 ppg & 227 ypg). They survived their toughest test yet, getting past Colorado (+6') LW in Boulder, 24-21. The close call snapped a streak of 5 straight covers going back to last year. BYU's offense lacks explosiveness and consistency but it hasn't needed too much from the attack to remain unbeaten. And the Cougs won't much this week either. BYU will shut down WVU, with a shutout in play. The offense will dominate on the ground as the Cougars coast to a 25-pt win.

SAN DIEGO ST by 7 over Colorado St - Since '05, San Diego St 10-3 SU & ATS vs Col St. Aztecs have covered 3 str and 5 of last 6 incl last mtg in '23 and LTH in '20. SD St 3-1 in Sean Lewis' second ssn. His trademark Flash Fast offense has hit the skids, avg just 17.7 ppg in FBS opp. But the D is picking up the slack, ranking top 10 nationally in scoring (9.8 ppg) and total D (237 ypg). Aztecs won LW without scoring a td, holding NIU (+2) to 179 yds in 6-3 win. They're 3-1 ATS and have not allowed a point in 2 home gms. Col St 1-3 and hitting the road for first time in over a month. Like Aztecs, Rams are stumbling on off (#131 in scoring) while the D has played well, allowing 18ppg last 3 wks. LW HC Norvell switched QB's but CSU never reached EZ in 20-3 loss to Wash St. It'll be another low-scoring slugfest this wk in a gm hinging on who has the better PK. SD St gets the slight edge at home, especially since it's been 5 weeks since CSU has left Fort Collins.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 4th

NAVY by 7 Air Force - Academies have met every year since 1972. Home tm 0-4 ATS last 4, with Navy(-10) rolling, 34-7, on road LY. Since '04, under 15-5-1 and the rivalry has featured 10 outright upsets (6 fr Navy & 4 fr AF). Mids navigated soft Sept by going 4-0 SU & 2-2 ATS. Their toughest opp was LW's visit from 3-2 Rice (+13'), which fell in Annapolis, 21-13. Owls scored 10 pts in final 7:05 to cover. Navy's trademark ground gm leads FBS with 352 rush ypg (6.5 ypc). After slipping to 5-7 a yr ago, AF appears to still be in rebuild mode. Since beating Bucknell, Falcons have lost 3 in a row SU & ATS. The offense has been fine, averaging 38ppg, but the defense has been a sieve. AF gave up at least 44 pts in losses to Utah St, Boise St, and Hawaii and ranks last in MWC scoring D and total D, but they do know how to defend the option. The AF offense will keep things competitive but Navy will wear down the Falcons and pull away for 7pt win.

OLD DOMINION by 24 over Coastal Carolina - Coastal has won and covered last 2 mtgs. In '23, Chants (E) won, 28-24, on road, and they won, 45-37, at home LY as a 5pt fav. But this a different ODU squad, and Coastal is struggling. Monarchs beat Liberty (+14') LW, 21-7, for first time to move to 3-1 SU & ATS. On a day the off misfired, the D held the Flames to 210 yds. Chants are 2-2 SU & ATS and scored just 20 pts in their first 3 gms. However, they stunned So Alabama (-15'), 38-20, in Mobile 2 wks ago and then got a bye to reboot. They were -126 yds and +3 in takeaways vs USA so score was deceiving. Still, it was a confident boost for a squad that needed a shot in the arm. Ricky Rahne's Monarchs are making plays on both side of the ball, and QB Colton Joseph is a dual-threat star. As ODU gets more accustomed to being a heavy fav, they'll dispose of inferior tms with fewer mistakes. Monarchs bounce Coastal by more than 3 td's.

GEORGIA by 24 over Kentucky - UGA has won the last 15 meetings but KY is 5-1 ATS. KY has held UGA to 30 points or less in their five covers but LTH the Dawgs put up 51 points and 608 yards in a 38 point win. KY is 2-2 SU/ATS. Last week they were +5' in QB Boley's first road start. SC had 2 defensive td's in the 1H and led 28-10 despite KY having a 191-136 yd edge. KY lost 35-13. UGA had their 33 game home win streak snapped LW vs Bama. UGA is 3-11-1 ATS as a HF L3Y but Kirby Smart is 10-6 ATS off a SU loss. UGA is #87 in our pass D rankings (64%, 6-3) but QB Boley is a big step down from Tenn's Aguilar and Bama's Simpson. Bulldogs are laying 20' points here and while we would normally go against Georgia laying 3 td's, the situation and matchup both favor the Dawgs so we see this being a blowout.

UTSA by 10 over TEMPLE - UTSA is 2-0 SU/ATS in this series with wins by 15 & 27. UTSA started 0-2 but they've won their last 2 (2-2 ATS TY). Temple has had expected losses to Oklahoma and GTech in their last 2. The Owls are 3-1 ATS. UTSA RB Robert Henry is #2 in the nation in rush yards (624, 9.2) and he's had over 140 rush yards in all 4 games. Temple allowed 307 rush (10.2) in their last game at GTech. UTSA is on an 0-3 ATS run as an AF but they were 9-3 the previous 3 years under Traylor. Roadrunners are laying under a td. We have UTSA with an edge on both offense and defense and they did play A&M tough and won in elevation at Colorado St so a game at Temple should be no issue.

UCF by 4 over Kansas - Second-ever mtg and Kansas' first reg ssn trip to Florida since 2008. Both programs are looking to bounce back from Week 5 losses. Jayhawks slipped to 3-2 with a 37-34 home loss to Cincinnati. They gave up 603 yds and allowed the GW td with 29 secs left. It was the second time in the last 3 gms Kansas was gashed on defense (Missouri had 595 yds WK 3). HC Leipold is 8-16 ATS on the road (1-4 as a road fav). UCF will look to take advantage with an offense that hasn't gotten much from the QB's the last 3 gms (2-2 ratio). Knights entered last week 3-0 and coming off a 34-9 win over UNC. But they were outplayed by Kansas St (-5') in the road opener, 34-20, despite rushing for more than 200 yds (6.0 ypc this ssn). UCF is a much better tm in Orlando, and Kansas got exposed in its only road trip of the opening month. Knights will lean on talented backs Myles Montgomery and Jaden Nixon to outscore Kansas in a close game.

LOUISVILLE by 1 over Virginia - Virginia has lost the last 3 meetings but covered the last two, only losing 31-24 (+20') and 24-20 (+7'). This is Virginia's 6th straight week playing and they just knocked off # Florida St 46-38 in OT. UL is 4-0 SU but 1-3 ATS. They trailed last week 17-0 2Q at Pitt before 2 ST's miscues brought the Cardinals back in the game. UL shut Pitt out in the 2H and won 34-7 for their first cover of the year. RB's Brown & Watson have been banged up and they only rushed for 53 (1.6) last week. UVA is putting up 46 ppg/540 ypg and 122 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. The defense is holding foes 35 ypg below their avg. UL is putting up 38 ppg/409 ypg and 67 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. Their D is holding foes to 268 ypg and 71 ypg below their avg. The question here is how much does UVA have left in the tank? The situation favors the home team but Virginia is 6-1 ATS off an upset under Elliott and on a 10-4 ATS run so we see another close game and play the dog.

MARYLAND by 3 over Washington - This is Washington's first-ever trip to College Park. In 4 trips to different time zones last year, Huskies went 0-4 SU & ATS at Rutgers, Iowa, Indiana & Penn St. Washington was one of the least exp'd teams LY and are much stronger in HC Fisch's 2nd yr. Maryland opened 4-0 SU and 3-1 ATS, including a big 27-10 road win at Wisconsin. They have won by 22 ppg but are just +68 ypg. True fr. QB Washington is hitting 60% with an 8-1 ratio! Maryland's D under-performed LY but is holding foes to 68 ypg below their average. Washington opened 3-0 SU and 2-0 ATS including a revenge win in the Apple Cup. Last week Washington lost to visiting Ohio St 24-6 (+9'). Maryland is fresh off a bye while Wash just faced 2 tough opp's and has 3 more games on deck (they face 5 teams off byes) and have the time zone shift. Early Vegas line favors Washington 5', but the situation greatly favors Maryland and we believe the Terps pull off the upset.

MICHIGAN by 21 over Wisconsin - Home team is 8-4 ATS since '05. Last time here in '20, Wisconsin (-6') out-rushed Michigan 341-47 in 49-11 min. After bye week, Badgers 5-4 SU (4-5 ATS) since '19. First meeting since '21. Wisconsin is 7-5 SU & 8-4 ATS since '05. Michigan started slow at 0-2 ATS with a road loss to Oklahoma where they were out FD'd 22-12. They took the reins off of true fr. QB Underwood and have covered their last 2, blowing out CMich 63-3 at home then having a 286-43 rush edge at Nebraska in a 3-point win, despite a 23-16 FD disadvantage. Wisconsin opened 2-0 then lost at Bama. The season took a turn south as they face the nation's toughest schedule and in one of their last games as a favorite this year they lost at home to Maryland 27-10. Both team are fresh off a bye. Michigan is 8-12-2 ATS as a HF the last 4 years. Wisconsin is 2-8 ATS as an AD the last 9 years. Early line has Mich -16', and we see them covering.

Clemson by 21 over NORTH CAROLINA - Clemson has won the last 6 meetings (5-1 ATS) but the home team is on a 6-0 ATS run. Clemson has their backs against a wall after a 1-3 start and two weeks ago they lost to Syracuse at home 34-21 though they did put up 503 yards. NC is 2-2 and their two losses were by 34 at home vs TCU and 25 at UCF. The Tar Heels are putting up just 264 ypg and they avg 122 ypg less than their foes allow (#135). Both teams are fresh off a bye. While Dabo Swinney was looking at everything in his program over their bye week, Bill Belichick was in Nantucket with his girlfriend strolling on the beach. Clearly Clemson is more upset about the way their season has started yet are laying just under 2 td's here. We expect a huge performance from Clemson's D, which has too much talent to play like they did against Syracuse. Clemson won't hold back if they get a lead so we are laying the points in a Circle the Wagon game.

OHIO ST by 20 over Minnesota - Gophers are 0-7 SU in Columbus dating back to '00 (3-4 ATS). Last time here in '23, Minn (+27') scored only points in 4Q of 37-3 loss. OSU has won 13 straight in series & 29 of L/30 (only loss '00). Bucks 7-6-1 ATS s/'00 (4-4 at home). OSU 28-22-2 ATS in B10 games as DD favorite. Ohio St was outgained by Texas 336-202 at home, but won by 7. Then were +438 ypg in a couple of home wins vs an FCS and MAC team. Last week Ohio St opened B10 play with a 24-6 win over Washington (-9'). RFr QB Sayin went 22-298-208 in his 1st career rd st. Minnesota opened 2-0 but lost at Cal late at night, 27-14. Last week Minn defeated Rutgers, 31-28 (-3') behind QB Lindsay's 3 TD passes. Since '14, Minn 12-4-2 as DD dog in B10 games (2-0 LY vs Mich/PSU). OSU is 12-6 ATS at home L3Y. Early Vegas line sees Ohio St -31', and we think Gophers will keep it a bit closer than that.

PITTSBURGH by 7 over Boston College - The home team in this series have won 3 straight SU/ATS. Pitt is 2-2 SU/ATS and they've had double-digit leads in both of their losses to WV and Louisville. Last week they were up 17-0 2Q despite not having RB Reid. They had 2 ST's miscues and were shutout in the 2H. QB Holstein was benched for their final drive and backup QB Gonzales threw an int. BC has lost 3 straight. They also had double-digit leads in the 1H of their last 2 losses to Stanford and Cal and they also lost in OT to Michigan St. BC avg 444 ypg but their D is allowing 34 ypg more than their foes avg (#105). Narduzzi announced they are sticking with Holstein and he does have an 11-5 ratio. Hard to trust either team right now but Pitt has more potential and if Reid returns they will have a big offensive spark.

Central Michigan by 1 over AKRON - Chippewas are 6-1 SU in Akron but are 1-4 ATS incl 0-2 s/'18. Last met in '23 in Mt Pleasant CM (-10) only won 17-10 despite 298-193 yd edge. Central opened season with an road upset at SJSU 16-14 (-13') but were then outscored 108-20 at Pitt & Mich. CM covered L/2 (as HF) incl LW beating instate rival EM 24-13 (-3'), never trailing & finishing with a 445-298 yd edge. They are using a 2-QB system with Joe Labas avg 112 ypg (74%, 5-1) and QB Angel Flores being their top rusher 289 yds (4.7 ypc). Zips were blown out by Nebraska 68-0 but only lost to Wyoming & UAB by a combined 13 pts (1-1 ATS). They beat FCS Duquesne 51-7 (-8') but LW faced a Toledo team off an upset loss & looking for revenge after losing to Akron LY & the Zips were steam rolled 45-3 (+20') being outgained 545-145. Akron is 9-3 ATS as a home dog, Central Michigan is 2-14 SU on the road and the home team is 8-2 ATS in the series. Everything says take Akron and they are getting nearly a td.

Ohio by 20 over BALL ST - Bobcats are 5-0 SU & ATS s/'15 vs the Cardinals incl LTH when Ohio (-4) won 32-18 in '22. LY Bobcats (-17') led 21-7 HT & 42-14 before allowing a late td to only win 42-21. Ohio QB Parker Navaro was 7-11-169-31 with 110 rush (2 td). TT Navarro has 208+ yds passing in every game except at Ohio St (94 yd) and is #2 rusher (321, 6.2). Ball St's only win is 34-29 (-3) over New Hampshire. They covered vs both Auburn (+42') & UConn (+21), only losing to UConn 31-25 thanks to a td & 2 pt conv w/29. Ball St QB Kiae Kelly is avg just 118 ypg (65%, 3-2) with 170 rush (2.7). While Ball St was outscored by a combined 73-3 vs two P5 Foes (1-1 ATS), Ohio only trailed Ohio St 10-3 HT (lost 37-9 (+29')), only lost to Rutgers 34-31 (+15') & beat West Virginia 17-10 (+3'). LW Ohio (-7.5) led 21-13 HT & beat BG 35-20. LY Ohio was 8-1 SU & 7-2 ATS in MAC play (1-0 TY) and we look for that trend to continue here.

BUFFALO by 13 over Eastern Michigan - Buffalo is 4-1 SU & ATS but home team has lost 4 straight SU & ATS and underdog has three straight outright upsets. Last year the Bulls (+1) led 17-0 at HT but just 23-20 mid 4Q before pulling away with a 75 yd td pass & 60 IR td for a 27-20 win. They also lost to an FCS team but somehow upset Louisiana at home 34-31 (+2). LW after EM avg'd 420 ypg vs FBS foes they were held to just 298 yds & a ssn low 13 pts vs CM losing 24-13 (+3'). Buffalo started an expected 1-1 SU (2-0 ATS) then struggled getting passed Kens St 31-28 (-23'). They led Troy 17-0 (-5') but then QB Roberson was knocked out of game & they lost 21-17. LW without Roberson they tied UConn 17-17 w/59 left but allowed a GW fg w/16 to lose 20-17. EM has usually done well as a road dog but TY is 0-3 SU & ATS in that roll. Roberson is probable to return so we will look for the Bulls to take care of business here.

Western Michigan by 17 over UMASS - This is UMass's first conference game since leaving the MAC after the 2015 ssn. They are now full members of the MAC. Only two previous meeting were

in 2012 & '13 during UMass's first time in the MAC ('12-'15) with Western Michigan going 2-0 SU & ATS. UMass lost to FCS Bryant 27-25 (-15) and has been outscored 131-23 in their 3 FBS games. They started 0-3 ATS but LW the Minutemen (+44') held Missouri to 42 pts trailing just 21-6 at HT. They did need a 60 yd IR to set up a 21 yd td drive but then had the xp blocked. The Broncos have been better than expected as between two losses to BigTen foes (1-1 ATS), WM (+10) led North Texas 27-17 4Q but lost in OT 33-30. They trailed Toledo 13-0 (+14) but down 13-6 scored a td w/52 left and went for the 2pt conv & won 14-13. LW their beat an undefeated Rhode Island 47-14 (-7). WM QB Broc Lowry looks to have won the QB battle avg 118 ypg (57%, 2-1) and is the leading rusher with 227 (4.1, 5 td). UMass QB Grant Jordan has taken over the last 3 games but is avg just 88 ypg in those 3 with an 0-1 ration. Look for the Broncos to cover here.

James Madison by 28 over GEORGIA ST - JMU leads series 4-0 and has covered last 2 yrs. In '24, Dukes (-14') won 38-7 and LTH in '23 they rolled 42-14 as 6pt fav behind ssn-best +339 yds. This yr's squad could be the best one since joining FBS in '22. JMU 3-1 SU and 4-0 ATS, with the only loss coming at unbeaten Louisville in a game they led in the 3Q. LW they mauled GaSouthern (+15'), 35-10, with a 479-192 edge in yds. Ga St comes out of bye 1-3 SU and 0-4 ATS, beating Murray St, 37-21. Against Ole Miss and Vandy, they allowed 133pts. Their D won't slow down the relentless JMU ground gm which ranks 10th in FBS at 249ypg and already has 5 100-yd rushers. Since 2014, the Panthers are 6-14-2 as a home dog in conf games and 1-7 ATS at home under HC McGee. They'll fall again to a Dukes squad that'll play keep-away with the rushing attack and suffocate the Panthers with one of the G5's top defenses (#5 in FBS at 3.8 ypp).

NORTHWESTERN by 14 over ULM - First meeting & ULM's first game vs B10 since 2011. Warhawks 0-4 SU & ATS all-time vs B10. Last 4 years, ULM is 2-7 ATS vs P4 opponents. Northwestern lost at Tulane 23-3 with QB Stone tossing 4 int's. They covered the next 2 with a FCS win and a back-door cover vs Oregon. Last week Northwestern beat UCLA 17-14 (-5'). ULM beat a poor FCS team and were waxed by Bama 73-0. They upset UTEP on the road. Last week ULM beat Arkansas St 28-16 (-1'). As a road dog since 2020, ULM 11-21 ATS (2-4 LY). Cats are 14-24-2 ATS vs non-conf opp. NW is 6-14-1 ATS as a home favorite & 1-5-1 as fav of 20+ the last 8 years. ULM is in a Sun Belt sandwich and Northwestern in a B10 sandwich. NW is 4-10-1 ATS as a DD favorite.

MEMPHIS by 28 over Tulsa - Memphis is 6-2 SU/4-4 ATS and the home team has covered 4 straight. Memphis is 5-0 SU & ATS this year. They've won 4 of their five games by 21 points or more and also upset Arkansas at home. Last week they did have a misleading final vs FAU. They only led 17-16 at half and it was 31-26 then Memphis scored 24 points in the final 10 minutes. Tulsa is 2-3 SU/ATS. Last week they were +15 vs Tulane and were tied 14-14 but didn't score again and lost by 17. Memphis offense avg 40 ppg/448 ypg including 247 rush ypg (6.0). Tulsa only avg 21 ppg/393 ypg and they have yet to top 23 points vs an FBS foe. Tulsa is a 21 pt dog despite all 3 of their losses being by 19 points or less but Memphis is a red hot team that has covered every game so our lean is with the Tigers.

TROY by 7 over South Alabama - 14th "Battle for the Belt". Troy out for revenge after 6gm series winning streak snapped LY in Mobile, 25-9. Last 3 at home, Trojans 3-0 SU and ATS incl 2-8-10 win in 2023 as 5 pt fav. Last 5 off bye week, Troy 4-1 ATS with 4 going under total. Trojans 2-2 SU and ATS, losing to Clemson and 5-0 Memphis. Before the break, they rallied from down 17 at Buffalo to win 21-17. The D ranks #42 at holding opp below their average, and the break was valuable for QB Tucker Kilcrease who stepped up after starter Goose Crowder was injured. USA is 1-4 with 4 straight losses. Jags have played well vs the tougher opp, covering against Tulane and Auburn, but lost by DD in last 2 gms with Coastal Carolina and North Texas. This is a situational spot that favors Troy. Not only are they seeking revenge for LY, but they're rested as USA plays for the 6th straight week and b2b road games. Trojans win by a td and get the cover at home.

NEBRASKA by 20 over Michigan St - Spartans are 4-9 all-time vs Nebraska but have won 4 of the last 6 since '13 (2-4 ATS). Three of last 4 meetings have been outright upsets. In Lincoln, Nebraska is 6-1 all-time (lost 41-28 in '13) vs Spartans. Last time here in '18, Huskers (+1') got 3 4Q FGs in 9-6 win. Since '14 Nebraska is 3-10 SU & ATS after bye (0-2 LY). HC Smith is 17-9 ATS as an AD and Nebraska just 20-26-2 ATS as a HF the last 11 years. Nebraska opened 3-0 but lost a showdown game to Michigan, 30-17, despite a 23-16 FD edge. Mich St opened 3-0 SU and 0-3 ATS and were outplayed by USC, but got a late 75-yard TD pass for the cover. Both teams had last week off. Nebraska is holding foes to 177 ypg below their average and allowing just 249 ypg. MSU is allowing 383 ypg. MSU is #110 in pass D while Nebraska is #1 with just 76 ypg (51%, 0-1)! Early Vegas line has Nebraska -10' and we see the Huskers easily covering that.

Miami, Oh by 3 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - NIU went 7-1 SU (3-5 ATS) vs Miami from '02-'15 but has dropped 4 straight SU & ATS (as Fav). LY Miami (-3) led 17-0 2Q but up just 17-9 needed a game sealing fg w/2:25 left (off an NIU fumble) to win 20-9. Miami (+17') only lost to Wisconsin 17-0 but then lost to Rutgers 45-17 (+14'). After a bye MU (+2) led UNLV 24-10 at HT with a 304-161 yd edge. Miami QB Finn suffered a head injury in 2Q throwing a IR td on the same play. Miami still led 24-10 4Q but were outscored 31-14 in 4Q losing 41-38 (GW td w/15). LW they cruised past Lindenwood 38-0 (-21') without Finn. Huskies are 1-3 SU & ATS. They have struggled on offense (10.3 ppg) but have allowed just 20 ppg holding both Maryland (20) & San Diego St (6) to ssn lows in pts & held Miss St to 24 through 3Q's. NIU is holding teams to 36 ypg under their avg while Miami is allowing foes 36 ppg over their avg. With NIU getting just under a td we will take the points here especially with Finn being questionable.

Penn St by 30 over UCLA - Lions trail series 4-3. It's their 1st reg szn Pasadena trip since '68 (PSU has played in 5 Rose Bowls). Lions 2-0 SU (0-2 ATS) vs LA schools last year (beat UCLA at home, 27-11, & USC, 33-30, at Coliseum). LY in Happy Valley, UCLA (+28) lost 27-11. UCLA was dominated by Utah, 43-10, in the opener, then trailed UNLV 23-3 in 7-point road loss & lost at home to New Mexico, 35-10. They let HC Foster go following that loss. Last week, UCLA lost to N'Western, 17-14 (+5'). Penn St opened 3-0 SU & 0-3 ATS vs 3 weak foes, allowing two back-door covers in the final seconds. LW, Penn St fell to Oregon at home, 30-24 in 2OT (-4'). Since 2016, UCLA is 6-21 SU & 13-13-1 ATS vs ranked opponents. Penn St is off a big home game vs Oregon and making a long trip. They are 5-1 ATS after a loss. UCLA is 7-3-1 ATS as a HD the last 5 years. While coming off a huge loss in their White-out Game, at least playing in the Rose Bowl should have Penn St avoiding a bigger letdown.

CALIFORNIA by 7 over Duke

CALIFORNIA (+) over Duke - Duke travels across country for an ACC game. These two last met in 1962-63. Cal is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS this year. Last week they trailed BC 14-0 just 8 minutes into the game but it was only 24-21 4Q and QB JKS threw a 51 yard td pass as Cal won 28-24 (+6). Duke caught Syracuse off their upset win over Clemson and without their starting QB. The Blue Devils won 38-3 (-5) with a 503-314 yd edge and were +3 TO's. Duke started the year 0-3 ATS but they've covered their last 2 games. They are playing their 2nd of B2B road games. QB Mensah has a 13-2 ratio but Cal has only allowed a 2-5 ratio and CB Ezekiah Masses leads the country with 4 int's. We are surprised the Bears are the dog here and Wilcox is 14-5 ATS as a home dog so this has huge upset potential and only makes sense for our Underdog POW!

Texas by 3 over FLORIDA - When these two met last year Florida was +22 and started a 3rd string walk-on QB. Texas led 35-0 and won 49-17. Both offenses have been disappointing. Texas avg 32 ypg and 439 ypg and they did put up 55 points and 607 yards against Sam Houston prior to their bye. Texas' D allows just 212 ypg and has held all 4 foes to their season low yards. Florida has lost 3 straight games. They were outgained by LSU but QB Lagway threw 5 int's. Two weeks ago they put up just 141 yards. QB Lagway was 12-23 for 61 yards and Florida lost 26-7 (+7). Florida's D is holding foes 69 ypg below their avg. Texas is #3 in our pass D rankings while Florida is #16. Arch Manning put up big numbers against Sam Houston but they are #130 in our pass D rankings. We look for a low scoring game and Texas wins by a fg.

FLORIDA ST by 1 over Miami, FL - FSU won 3 straight between '21-'23 but last year Miami was -21 and led 36-7. FSU scored a td with :18 left for a 36-14 final. The Under is 11-3 including 4 straight covers in this series. Miami is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS and fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they had a 344-141 yd edge and beat Florida 26-7. The 'Canes D is allowing just 245 ypg and they've held foes 140 ypg below their avg as all 4 foes had season low yards vs the 'Canes D. FSU was 3-0 and #8 heading into last week but lost at Virginia 46-38 in OT. The 'Noles ave put up the most yards all 4 foes have allowed and held all 4 foes to season low yards. FSU is rushing for a gawdy 336 (6.7) but takes on a run D that allows just 76 rush ypg (2.6). FSU has the edge on offense, Miami has the edge on defense, and ST's are even. FSU has already beat Bama at home and a win here keeps them in the ACC Title race. We like the rivalry dog here to pull the upset.

Illinois by 14 over PURDUE - Illini have lost 15 of last 22 meetings but snapped 4-game losing streak last year. Purdue has won 7 of last 9. Since 2001, 8 of 22 games have been outright upsets & dog has covered 14 times. Out of a bye week, Boilers 3-7 SU & 4-6 ATS L/10. Purdue has a new HC and roster and Illinois is off a 10-win season, but just had major games vs Indy and USC and have Ohio State on deck while Purdue is fresh off a bye (big schedule edge). Illinois opened 3-0 with a win at Duke and was in the top 10 but were thrashed by Indiana 63-10. Last week Illinois got a last play FG to edge USC, 34-32 (+6). Purdue opened 2-0 then covered at home vs USC (losing by 16) and lost at Notre Dame by 26 but did have 368 ypg in those. Illinois is 4-0 AF here under HC Bielema. Early Vegas line has Illinois -9 and we see it easily covering that spread.

RICE by 3 over Fau - The visitor is 5-0 ATS in this series. Rice won the last meeting in '23 24-21 but FAU covered as 3 pt dogs. FAU is 1-3 SU/ATS but they are +53 ypg and off a misleading 29 pt loss to Memphis. They only trailed 31-26 4Q then allowed 24 points in the final 10 minutes. QB Veltkamp has thrown for 1,198 but only an 8-7 ratio. This will be their first test against an option team. Rice is 3-2 SU/ATS and they've covered both AAC games so far. Last week they were outgained 455-234 but only lost 21-13 (+13) at Navy. The Owls only allow 51% completions but they've taken on three poor pass offenses. FAU has a huge ST's edge (#8 vs #110) which could be a big factor in a close game.

Texas Tech by 7 over HOUSTON - Red Raiders have won 11 of last 12 and are 5-1-1 ATS last 7. This is Texas Tech's first gm since statement 34-10 road win over Utah. Last wk's bye gave them a chance to heal, particularly QB Behren Morton who was knocked out of the Utah gm. Red Raiders have the 130th ranked schedule after opening with Ark-Pine Bluff, Kent St and winless Oregon St, so beating the Utes has shifted oddsmakers' perception of the tm. This is a huge opportunity for Houston which wants to break into the Big 12 discussion. Cougars are 4-0 SU & 3-1 ATS but are coming off their worst performance and first ATS loss. They needed OT to beat common opponent Oregon St, 27-24, which Texas Tech mauled at home, 45-14, 2 weeks earlier. Houston was out-gained 390-352 and the ranks next to last in Big 12 ypg (5.5). Willie Fritz was 3-2 ATS LY as a DD dog, with 2 outright upset. His Cougars will stay close but lose by a td.

TCU by 17 over Colorado - First meeting as Big 12 rivals and first since Colorado (+20') stunned TCU, 45-42, in Fort Worth in Deion Sanders 2023 HC debut. Horned Frogs HC Sonny Dykes has not forgotten that loss and would like to even the score. Frogs also want to get back on track after suffering first loss LW at Arizona St (-3), 27-24, in a gm they led at start of 4Q. TCU 2-0-1 ATS vs FBS teams this year and the offense is generating 96yds above opposing defenses' average. Buffs slipped below .500 with LW's 24-21 loss to BYU (-6'). They scored the first 14 pts but couldn't protect the lead in the 2H. Colorado is 2-1-1 ATS in Boulder but lost, 36-20, at Houston (-4') in their only other road trip. Led by QB Josh Hoover (11 td passes), TCU has too much offensive firepower for a Colorado team still trying to find continuity and consistency at QB. Frogs bounce back after LW's disappointing loss and race past the Buffaloes by more than 2 td's.

BAYLOR by 4 over Kansas St - Last year was first since 2009 teams didn't play. Kansas St has won last 2 mtgs in '22 & '23 in blowouts. Baylor wants revenge but they also want to stay in the Big 12 title hunt after losing a heartbreaker to Arizona St, 27-24, in Week 4. Bears bounced back by beating Oklahoma St (+21) LW, 45-27. Baylor is explosive on offense (#11 in yds above opp defenses' avg) but struggling on D (#114 in yds allowed above opp defenses' avg). Kansas St is 2-3 after its first win over an FBS tm, beating UCF, 34-20, as a 5'pt fav. Wildcats were a different team with RB Dylan Edwards in the lineup (20-166-1 after just 4 carries first 4 gms). Before LW, KSU had lost 4 straight ATS. This is a high-scoring toss-up game that could come down to which offense has the ball last. The Wildcats are 0-3 this yr in 1-score gms vs FBS opponents. With the better overall weapons, Baylor will send the Cats to 0-4, rallying for a single-digit home win.

Army by 3 over UAB - Last year they met for the first time in 20 years and Army won 44-10 (-27') with a 515-303 yd edge. While UAB's defense has been horrendous, allowing 482 ypg, they have already seen the option, are fresh off the bye with extra time to prep and DC Steve Russ was DC at Air Force from '12-'17. UAB does have a potent offense that is putting up 437 ypg. QB Kitna is hitting 72% w/a 8-4 ratio. Army lost last Thursday at East Carolina 28-6 and were outgained 431-290. Army is a 7 point road favorite and we expect the Blazers D to be well prepped to face the option and keep this game closer than expected.

SMU by 23 over Syracuse - The only prior meeting was back in 1932! SMU is fresh off a bye. They are 2-2 SU but 0-4 ATS though they did lead in the 2H of both losses. Syracuse upset Clemson two

weeks ago but lost QB Angeli for the season and the offense struggled last week vs Duke. They were outgained 319-158 in the first half and lost 38-3. QB Collins threw for 229 yards and 1 int. Cuse's D is allowing 465 ypg and 23 ypg more than their foes avg. This is their 6th week playing and SMU is off a bye. The Mustangs have the edge on offense and while their pass D is giving up 335 ypg, Cuse looked much less potent with Collins at QB. The situation favors SMU and we have the home team winning by more than 3 td's.

UCONN by 8 over FIU - Series tied 1-1 SU & ATS ('22 & '23) with Visitor 2-0 SU & ATS, Last met in '23 FIU (+7) never trailed leading 24-3 at HT with a 294-119 yd edge. UConn scored 14 unanswered in 2H but were SOD at FIU9 w/55 left to lose 27-17. Both played Delaware in back-to-back weeks. UConn (-8) at Delaware led 24-21 2Q before allowing a 68 yd td pass to trail 28-24 at HT despite a 325-303 yd edge. Huskies led 38-35 but gave up a game tying fg as time expired. They lost in OT 44-41 despite a 521-512 yd edge. FIU (-4) at home only led 7-3 1Q trailing 24-7 at HT being outgained 203-155. FIU never got closer than 14 losing 38-16 but finished with a 363-358 yd edge. Both have a bye on deck. FIU is 3-1 ATS (2-2 SU), In the Huskies only other SU loss they led Syracuse 17-6 into 4Q but needed a fg w/01 to send to OT but lost 27-20. TY they have never trailed at the end of 4Q but are 0-3-1 ATS vs FBS foes. Look for them to keep it close to the line as while they should win here their ATS record has us looking elsewhere for a play.

NOTRE DAME by 24 over Boise St - First mtg. Notre Dame is 7-2 SU but just 3-6 ATS vs G5 teams but some of those losses are a big favorite looking past a little known team. Boise made the playoffs last year so Notre Dame will be up for this game and the Irish are 5-1 ATS their L/6 vs MWC foes. Notre Dame also needs to play perfect the rest of the way. After opening with two losses to ranked teams by a combined 4 pts the Irish have won by 26 & 43. That blowout win at Arkansas cost the Razorbacks their HC. Boise was shocked in their opener losing 34-7 (-5.5) at USF. They have covered 3 straight as a DD favorite but only got past Air Force 49-37 (-11). While the Broncos come in with a better record, Notre Dame has faced the #1 toughest schedule while Boise has faced the #104. We look for Notre Dame to show they are the better team.

OKLAHOMA by 49 over Kent St - These two met in '22 when OK won 33-3 (-33). That was Brent Venables 2nd game as HC here. The Sooners are 4-0 SU/ATS including ATS wins as large chalk against Illinois State and Temple. They will be without QB John Mather this week. Backup Michael Hawkins started 4 games last year and brings a dual threat ability but likely won't run much this week. Kent State was no match for Florida St prior to their bye and trailed 48-0 at half against Texas Tech but scored two 4Q td's and covered by a half point. Oklahoma has the Red River Showdown on deck so they won't go all out for four quarters. It's not a good situation for Oklahoma but we can't see backing the dog here.

Texas A&M by 17 over Mississippi St - A&M has won the last two in this series but didn't cover last year laying 19' (34-24 win). The home team is 8-3 ATS in this series and the last 4 meetings have gone Over the total. A&M is 4-0 SU but 1-3 ATS and the Aggies are now 4-13 ATS under Mike Elko. Last week they dominated every facet of the game against Auburn but only won 16-10 (-6') despite a 414-177 yd edge. MSU is 5-0 ATS this year. They were never behind the spread last week vs Tenn despite giving up 2 defensive td's. MSU led 34-27 4Q but Tenn tied the game with 1:55 left and won in OT. Bulldogs offense is holding foes 73 ypg below their avg. This will be MSU's first time leaving the state of Mississippi. MSU is 12-5 ATS under Lebby including 4-1 ATS as a road dog. We still like A&M but they aren't covering under Elko so we only have a small lean on the Aggies.

WYOMING by 3 over UNLV - Since '04, home tm and the over are 10-4 ATS in this series. UNLV has dropped 6 straight in Laramie (1-5 ATS). Meanwhile, Wyoming is 19-8 ATS as a HD last 10 yrs, so they have a big home edge here, espec vs a tm unaccustomed to playing outdoors and at an elevation. Rebels have done well to start 4-0 in Dan Mullen's debut but the unbeaten mark falls to show how they've struggled against a weak state. Plus, the D allows 5.4 ypc and 101yds more than opposing offenses' avg (#125 in FBS). Wyoming, like UNLV, is coming out of a bye. Cowboys 2-2 SU & ATS but both losses came in last 2 gms with Utah and Colorado. They'll be happy to see a non-P4 team this wk. Wyoming averages just 16.8 ppg but should be able to spring the backs against the soft UNLV D. True frosh Samuel Harris has rushed for 184 yds last 2 gms. Rebels are not as good as their record and always struggle in Laramie. Wyoming holds on by a fg.

Texas St by 17 over ARKANSAS ST - Last 5 in series, Texas St 4-1 SU & 3-2 ATS. Bobcats avenged a 77-31 loss in '23 with LY's 41-9 home win as a 13'pt favorite. They're 3-1 with the only loss coming at Arizona St (-17'), 34-15. GJ Kinne's offense leads the SBC in scoring at 36.3 ppg and QB Brad Jackson is really coming into his own as the leader of the attack (6-1 ratio). Bobcats also have a significant situational edge this wk; while they're coming off a bye, Arkansas St is playing for a 6th straight wk and on an 0-5 ATS slide last 5 gms heading into a bye. This is a brutal matchup for a rebuilt Red Wolves D that's allowing 94 more yds than the opposing offense's average (#130 in the FBS). Star WR Corey Rucker is coming off his best gm of the year, catching 10 for 117 after only having 8 rec in the first 4 gms. So, ASU should put up points and push this game to the over. However, they don't match well with Texas St and will fall by 17 at home.

FRESNO ST by 14 over Nevada - Fresno St on 4-0 run in series but just 1-2-1 ATS. Home tm is 0-3-1 ATS last 4 and just 2-11-1 going back to 2011. Both tms are coming out of byes. Bulldogs entered the break 4-1 with a 4-game winning streak since losing in Week 0 at Kansas. Their best wins are over Georgia Southern, 42-14, as a 1'pt HD and 23-21 road win at Hawaii (+3). Nevada is 1-3 with the lone win over Sacramento St, 20-17, as a 7'pt favorite. They've lost 3 straight ATS incl a 14-13 loss in Reno to MTSU as a 9'pt favorite. The defense has been solid since the Penn St opener, allowing 21ppg, but the offense is getting nothing from the passing gm (2-7 ratio) and is gaining 45yds less than opposing D's average (114th in FBS). Fresno St is learning how to win under first-yr HC Matt Entz and will benefit from the break after 5 straight wks of action. Nevada lacks the offensive consistency to snap FSU's streak and will fall in the Valley by 2 td's.

4★ Detroit over CINCINNATI - DET is 8-0 SU (7-1 ATS) as an AF, while CIN is 0-2 SU/ATS as an HD; yes, H2H leans CIN 7-0 SU (6-1 ATS), but the current numbers tilt DET. LW splits were lopsided: DET 34-10 (Amon-Ra 7-70-2, Gibbs 15-91-1, plus a PR TD; Hutchinson 2 sk, FF) vs CIN's 3 pts at DEN (Browning 14/25 for 125, eight punts, 512 yds allowed/29 first downs). Overlay the profiles (#1 PPG and #1 4Q scoring for DET vs CIN #30 PPG/#31 4Q) and the situational trends (DET 11-2 ATS off a 14+ pt win and 8-0 ATS after allowing <250 yds; CIN 1-4 ATS after a 14+ pt loss), and the edge stays with the road side. "Capt. Checkdown" Browning (125 yds on 25 att — 5.0 YPA) now walks into a rush keyed by Hutchinson, which lets DET sit on routes and squeeze the underneath windows. With DET dominating offense this one is poised to be a blowout.

FORECAST: Detroit by 20

3★ ARIZONA over Tennessee - Trends lean red: ARI is 3-0 SU/ATS vs TEN the past decade and 6-1 ATS at home vs losing road records, while TEN is 0-6 SU/ATS after B2B losses and 1-5 SU (2-4 ATS) when catching +7+. LW TEN was blanked on the scoreboard with just 175 total yds and 10 first downs (Cam Ward 10/26, 108 pass yds), and they're 0-6 ATS after <150 pass yds. ARI pushed SEA late (20 pts in the 4Q; Tyler 27/41, 200, 2-2; MHJ 6-66-1) despite 6 sacks, and the RB room still has answers with James Conner out—Trey Benson DNP Mon, but Emari Demercado (9.3 YPC LY) is a live plug-in who could see more work if Benson is limited after logging spot usage recently. TEN's skill health is shaky (Ridley "fighting through something"; Tyjae Spears may return), but the offense hasn't hit 20 since Wk1. **FORECAST: Arizona by 17**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ LA CHARGERS over Washington - H2H leans LAC (2-0 SU/ATS last 9 yrs), and this sets up well off the spot: Chargers are 5-0 ATS after an ATS loss, while WAS is 0-4 ATS after sub-150 pass yds in the prior game. LW numbers back it up—LAC still put up 344 yds vs NYG (Herbert 23/41 for 203 & TD; Hampton 12-128-1) but got stung by 2 INTs, whereas WAS surrendered 313 pass yds to ATL and 150+ scrimmage to Bijan (Mariota 156-2-1 kept it close, but the D cracked). With YPG ranks tilting to efficiency (LAC #8 total O vs WAS #11; WAS #2 rush YPG vs LAC #5 pass YPG) there is likely to be scoring in this one but LAC should bounce back well here. Jayden Daniels (knee) day-to-day is worth monitoring but doesn't change the prediction here. Chargers win big.

FORECAST: Los Angeles by 10

OTHER PLAYS

San Francisco vs LA RAMS - TNF - LAR enters with the recent edge (3-0 SU/ATS H2H), plus 4-0 ATS last 4 at home and 4-0 ATS on Thursdays, while SF is 0-4 ATS off an ATS loss; totals lean Over (SF off SU loss 4-0, LAR off SU win 4-0, and SF road vs winning home teams 7-1-1). LW: SF moved it through the air (Purdy 22/38, 309, 2-2; CMC 6-92-1) but turned it over 4x vs JAX; LAR rallied past IND behind Stafford (29/41, 375, 3 TD) with Nacua erupting (13-170-1) and Kyren adding 77 rush. Injuries to monitor: SF's pass-game shuffle with George Kittle (IR) and WR nicks (Jennings/Pearsall statuses), while Puka Nacua's thumb X-ray was clean. SF good at bouncing back while LAR play strong at home.

Minnesota by 3 over Cleveland - London Early Game - MIN's pass game traveled in Dublin (Wentz 30/46, 350, 2-2; Jefferson 10-126), but 6 sacks show protection stress; the matchup still tilts toward MIN because CLE's offense is the bigger issue: Flacco went 16/34 for 184 with 2 INT in a 10-pt output vs DET, but the key to their woes are the WR room ranking last in separation, they've allowed a league high 73 QB pressures, and the run game sits at 84.8 rush YPG (3rd worst). Judkins (21-82-1) is a bright spot starting to trend positive, and trendwise CLE is 5-1 ATS after allowing 30+, but the passing rhythm and red-zone consistency favor MIN after a close cover try (Vikings 5-1 ATS off an ATS loss). The difference here might just be MIN staying abroad on B2B Europe game (Dublin LW), while CLE has QB uncertainty with Flacco rumored to be benched for Dillon Gabriel, it would be a tough start against this MIN D.

CAROLINA by 3 over Miami - MIA snapped its skid LW (27-21) but now must recalibrate without Tyreek (out for yr); LW was Tua 17/25, 177, 2 TD with Achane 20-99-1, and the Jets' 13 penalties/3 TOs helped. CAR's offense was quiet (Bryce 18/30, 150, 1 TD), but Bank of America has been friendly (CAR 6-1 ATS L7 home) and trends tilt their way: CAR 4-0 ATS after scoring <15, while MIA 1-4 ATS off a SU win; H2H leans MIA (2-0 SU/ATS), yet with PPG close (CAR #26, MIA #21) and Hill sidelined, the spot points to a tight CAR edge.

Dallas by 4 over NY JETS - DAL's offense is humming off the 40-40 shootout (Prescott 31/40, 319, 3 TD + rush TD; Pickens 8-134-2; J. Williams 20-85-1) and they lead the league in YPG with a big 2Q PPG edge. NYJ piled up yardage (404 total; Fields 226 pass/81 rush) but continue to beat themselves: 13 penalties, 3 giveaways, 0 takeaways on the season (-7 TO margin) and league-high missed tackles. Angles tilt DAL: AF 4-1 SU; NYJ as HD 0-4 SU (1-3 ATS) and 2-8 ATS last 10 at home vs losing road teams; PPG ranks favor DAL #5 vs NYJ #19, and DAL's YPG edge (#1 vs #21) reinforces the Cowboys win.

INDIANAPOLIS by 10 over Las Vegas - IND owns the yardage edge (397.2 YPG vs LV 329.5) and Daniel Jones has tossed a TD in all 4 games TY, with Taylor adding 17-76 LW to keep the offense on schedule. H2H last 5 yrs leans IND 3-1 SU (2-2 ATS), and when laying points TY the Colts are 2-0 SU/ATS; they also tend to bounce back offensively after an ATS loss (Over 6-0; 8-2 after <90 rush yds). LV comes off a mistake-heavy trip to CHI (4 giveaways; Geno 117 pass, 2 TD, 3 INT) despite Jeanty's 21-138-1, and the passing game remains shaky. Cleaner QB play plus the YPG gap point to IND at home; note IND WR Alec Pierce (concussion protocol) and LV TE Michael Mayer (concussion) are TBD. The Colts should bounce back after LW loss and win big here.

PHILADELPHIA by 1 over Denver - PHI keeps stacking wins despite a bottom-3 YPG offense (251.5, #30) thanks to situational edges (Eagles 6-1 ATS after scoring 30+) and a defense/ST that flipped TB with a blocked-punt TD; LW Hurts went 15/24 for 130 with 2 TD (15/16, 2 TD in 1H) and added 9-62 rushing, while Goedert posted 4-37-2. DEN just rolled CIN 28-3 behind Nix's 29/42, 326, 2 TD and a revived run game (Dobbins 16-101), but trends are rough away from home (Broncos 0-5 ATS last 5 road) and they now face a step-up defense. Market notes lean Over-ish (Over 6-1 in DEN after allowing <15), yet matchup profile favors a grind: DEN 354.5 YPG vs PHI 251.5, with PHI's red-zone/takeaway moments often the separator.

NEW ORLEANS by 6 over NY Giants - NYG just got a spark from rookie QB Dart (13/20, 111, 1 TD; 54 rush) and 79 rush from Skatkebo, but they also cashed 11 points off LAC turnovers and now lose WR Malik Nabers (ACL), stripping the WR room of its alpha. NO leaned on the ground vs BUF (189 rush) while Spencer Rattler threw for 126 and the Saints' trend fits: 6-1 ATS after <150 pass yards; NYG is 0-5-1 ATS off an ATS win and 0-6 ATS after 150+ rush yards in

the prior game. With both defenses leaky (PPG allowed: NO #30, NYG #23) the matchup tilts to NO's run-first script and situational edges despite NYG's LW pop.

BALTIMORE by 3 over Houston - Line flipped from BAL -7.5 to BAL +2 on the Lamar hamstring news (expected out 2-3 wks - QB Cooper Rush likely to start), but the matchup data still nudges BAL: H2H is BAL 5-0 SU/ATS and C.J. Stroud has yet to throw a TD vs BAL in three meetings. LW, HOU finally broke through (26-0 vs TEN) behind Stroud's 22/28 for 233 and Woody Marks' 69 & TD, yet the offense sits #24 YPG while BAL's defense profile is better (#13 YPG) and just faced KC (Mahomes 270, 4 TD) after Lamar exited. Angles cut both ways—BAL as HD 0-4 SU (2-1-1 ATS) vs HOU as AF 3-0 SU (2-1 ATS)—but with BAL 4-0 to the Over and HOU 4-0 to the Under, expect a tug-of-war on tempo; slight lean to the home side's defensive rank and series dominance in a tight one.

Tampa Bay by 3 over SEATTLE - H2H last 7 yrs is split (TB 1-1 SU, 1-0-1 ATS), and this sets up as fast-start SEA vs bounce-back TB: SEA is #2 in 1Q scoring while TB is #30 in 1Q scoring allowed, but TB is #4 in 2Q scoring allowed and 3-0 ATS as an AD with strong response angles (5-0 ATS off a SU loss; 6-1 ATS after 350+ yds). LW TB still moved it (Baker 289-2-1; B. Irving 165 scrimmage yds), while SEA rode efficiency (Darnold 18/26, 242-1; Walker 19-81) and a pass rush that logged 6 sacks vs ARI. If B. Irving (foot) can't go, TB leans on RB Rachaad White (4.7 YPC TY), and WR Chris Godwin (3 REC in his return LW) should ramp up to help cover for the absence of Mike Evans (hamstring). We see this one as an end of game, last sec fg win after a Baker led drive down the field.

New England vs BUFFALO - SNF - H2H leans BUF 6-2 SU (but 0-4 ATS last four), and both offenses bring early juice: BUF is #2 in PPG and #2 in 1Q scoring, NE sits #10 PPG and #8 in 1Q scoring. LW, BUF handled NO 31-19 (Allen 16/22, 209, 2 TD + rush TD; Cook 22-117-1) while NE hammered CAR 42-13 (Maye 203 pass yds, 2 TD + rush TD; Marcus Jones 167 PR yds with a TD). Trend tape tilts toward points—Over is 9-1 for NE vs winning teams and 4-0 for BUF after allowing <150 pass yds—while situationally BUF has responded well after ATS stumbles (5-1 ATS after an ATS loss) even as NE is 0-4 ATS after an ATS win, then again NE is 4-0 ATS H2H.

Kansas City vs JACKSONVILLE - MNF - KC leads H2H 5-0 SU (4-1 ATS); LW KC: Mahomes 25/37, 270, 4 TD vs BAL, while JAX rode Etienne (19-124-1) and a 4-TO defense to beat SF. Trends: JAX 6-1-1 ATS last 8 at home; Monday splits are shaky on both sides (JAX 1-6 ATS, KC 1-5 ATS). Totals angles diverge—JAX Over 6-0 off a SU win and 5-0 after 150+ rush; KC Under 4-0 after 250+ pass. Metrics are tight (PPG: KC 24.2, JAX 24.0; YPG rank: JAX #10, KC #16), setting up a tempo tug-of-war between KC's aerial efficiency and JAX's run-led balance behind Etienne under the lights.
