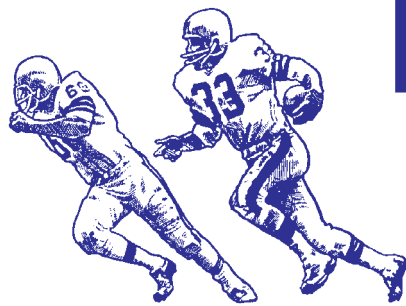

4★ Alabama over Missouri - Bama is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in this series, winning those by 28.6 ppg and the closest game was by 19 points. This game features the SEC's leading passer in Bama's Ty Simpson (1478, 70%, 13-1) and the FBS' leading rusher in Mizzou's Ahmad Hardy (730, 7-1). Last week we caught some good luck for once, with Bama tacking on a late td to cover against Vandy which gave us a 4★ LPS and Newsletter winner. Mizzou is 5-0 SU but their best win is against a 2-loss South Carolina team. Missouri has won 15 straight home games but Bama already ended Georgia's 33 game home win streak a few weeks ago. FORECAST: ALABAMA by 18

3★ ARIZONA over BYU - BYU takes its 5-0 record to Tucson where Arizona is 4-0 SU & ATS this ssn. Wildcats' only loss came at Iowa St (-5), 39-14. They just handled OkSt (+20'), 41-13, behind 5 Noah Filita td passes. Filita has a 13-3 ratio incl 11-1 at home. The D is allowing opp 126 yds below their avg (#15 FBS) and the top-ranked pass D boasts an 0-7 ratio! The Arizona secondary presents problems for true frosh BYU QB Bear Bachmeier (7-1 ratio, 5 rush td's). BYU isn't quite as solid as their record looks. Cougars' best win so far was at Colorado, 24-21, in a gm they trailed in the 4Q and failed to cover. The defense is terrific, ranking #8 in FBS in ypg allowed (239.6), so we expect a tight, low-scoring gm. Arizona has been so good in the desert and BYU is ripe to suffer its first loss. Cats scratch out 4 pt win to remain in Big 12 race.

FORECAST: ARIZONA by 7

3★ † Oklahoma over Texas - OK's QB John Mateer was out last week against Kent St but he could possibly return much sooner than expected. Backup QB Michael Hawkins actually started this game last year but the Sooners are missing their top 5 WR's and multiple Oline starters and Texas won 34-3. The Sooners are 5-0 and we cashed 2H winners on them against Michigan and Auburn. OK is +222 ypg and their D is allowing just 193 ypg and holds foes 181 ypg below their avg. Texas's only impressive win was against winless 0-5 Sam Houston. Last week UT was -7 at Florida. Their defense gave up a season high 457 yards and they lost 29-21. Arch Manning has a 3-3 ratio against P4 teams this year. The 'Horns are just 4-11 ATS since beating the Sooners LY. Oklahoma has been the better team by all metrics this year yet they are still the underdog.

2★ FLORIDA ST over Pittsburgh - These two last met in '23 when FSU was -21' and only led 10-7 at half. FSU scored two 3Q td's and won 24-7. FSU has lost their last two games. LW they trailed Miami 28-3 but actually had a chance to cover late and settled for a fg. HC Narduzzi turned to true frosh Mason Heintschel against BC. Pitt led 31-0 w/a 331-69 yd edge at half and Pitt won 48-7. Heintschel threw for 323 yards and 4 td's. Heintschel is making his first road start against an FSU D that allows just 196 pass ypg (#30 pass D, 61%, 9-6). Norvell is 3-7 ATS off a loss the last 2 years. Pitt had DD leads in both games they lost to LVille and WVU so they could actually be 5-0 but they are 2-9 SU/ATS on the road the last 3 years. We have FSU by 2 td's.

FORECAST: FLORIDA ST by 17

2★ KENT ST over UMass - Last met in 2015, Kent St got the outright upset 15-10 as a 7 pt AD. With just 1 win between them you would expect these teams to be equally bad. That is not the case the Minutemen are 0-5 SU & 1-4 ATS with their only cover coming vs then #20 Missouri as a 44' pt AD in a 42-6 loss (only td set up by 63 yd IR, PAT blk). Flashes are 1-4 SU but 3-2 ATS despite playing a much tougher schedule (#9-#63). They have played #24 Texas Tech, #7 Florida St and LW #5 Oklahoma (2-1 ATS). In their other loss, they led Buffalo 14-0 2Q & 28-24 4Q before giving up a GW td w/1:03. UMass has not scored over 10 pts in a game vs FBS foes (#134 FBS) while Kent St has 28 vs Buffalo and their 14 pts vs TT is tied for most the Red Raiders have allowed this year. As just a 3 pt HF, we will go with the better team off a killer schedule.

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 8th

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 3 over Missouri St - These two last met in 1986. MT is 1-4 SU/ATS. They only trailed Wisky 14-10 at half, led Marshall to start 4Q and had a 460-334 yd edge vs Kennesaw but lost all 3 games. Their only win was at Nevada. MSU beat Marshall 21-20 and had a 474-274 yd edge. They played SMU tough in a 28-10 loss and two weeks ago lost to WKU 27-22. Middle Tenn has the edge on offense but Missouri St has the edge on defense. Middle Tenn has allowed 18 sacks while MSU has allowed 19 but MT's Dline has been a little better. MT is 3-14 ATS under Mason but if they want to reach a bowl, they need to win some home games and we think MT is better than their record. UTEP by 7 over Liberty - Liberty has won both CUSA meetings but UTEP is 2-0 ATS. Last year Lib was -23' and they only won 28-10. Both teams come in 1-4 but Liberty is far more disappointing after being picked to win CUSA in preseason. Two weeks ago Liberty was +14' against ODU. They were outgained 274-71 in the 1H but snuck a cover, losing 21-7. UTEP is 2-3 ATS on the season. They lost 30-11 (+3') against Louisiana Tech but did have a 273-232 yd edge. The Miners D is holding foes 47 ypg below their avg. UTEP's Udoka Ezeani leads CUSA with 4 sacks and the Miners are #1 in CUSA with 15. Liberty has allowed 14 sacks. Lib has just 132 pass yards in their L2 games and QB Vasko was benched against ODU. UTEP has the better QB and the better Dline so they are the pick here.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 9th

Louisiana Tech by 10 over KENNESAW ST - This is LT's first trip to KSU. LT won last year's meeting 33-0 w/a 437146 yard edge. This year LT is off to a 4-1 start and the are 5-0 ATS. Jerry Mack has done a remarkable job in his first year at KSU. They've won their last 3 games and are 3-2 ATS on the season. LT has the edge on defense but KSU has the edge on offense, led by QB Amari Odom (72%, 4-1, 172 rush). Cumbie is just 3-23 SU on the road and while they did beat UTEP 30-11, they only put up 232 yards in that game. KSU's Dline won't be as disruptive as UTEP's, so we expect LT's offense to move the ball much better but we can't trust LT to cover on the road against the improving Owls.

Southern Miss by 3 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - First mtg as SBC foes. Both tms coming off bye week. Georgia Southern is 2-3 SU/ATS. However, Eagles are 2-0 SU & ATS at home, and 3 losses came at Fresno St, USC and JMU. GS is allowing opponents 87 more yds than their average which ranks 134th in FBS. This is just the second road trip for USM which is 3-2 SU/ATS. In their first road trip, they lost at LT, 30-20, but were +174 yds and +15 fd's. They outplayed LT but allowed a crucial pick6 and failed to convert in the RZ. USM HC Huff is 16-10 ATS away from home going back to his days at Marshall (6-1 ATS LY). He has the better QB in Braylon Braxton (64.9%, 11-3 ratio) and this bye will be especially valuable to a team with so many newcomers. With a more complete squad, we like USM to earn a key conf road win Thursday night.

Jacksonville St by 7 SAM HOUSTON - These two joined CUSA together 2Y ago and Jax St has won both meetings. Both teams brought in new HC's this year. SH's Phil Longo is off to an 0-5 SU/ATS start, with all 5 games being losses by 17 points or more and they are -215 ypg. JSU's Charles Kelly has the Gamecocks more competitive. They are 2-3, losing all 3 road games but two of those losses were by just 7 points at UCF and Georgia Southern and they had the yds edge at SMiss. Jax St is rushing for 262 ypg (5.7). SH is allowing 70% and 322 pass ypg. We think Kelly gets his first road win and Sam Houston's struggles continue.

TULANE by 7 East Carolina - Tulane is 5-1 SU in this series and the home team is 9-3 ATS. In '23

Tulane struggled to get distance on opponents and only won 13-10 (-17) but they did have a 368-190 yd edge. Tulane is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS. They beat both Duke and Northwestern at home. In their AAC opener they were -15 at Tulsa. Tulane led 31-14 3Q and Tulsa was SOD at the Tulane6 on the final drive. EC is 3-2 SU/4-1 ATS. Pirates QB Katin Houser is hitting 68% w/a 7-4 ratio while Tulane's Retzlaff is only hitting 54% w/a 2-0 ratio. Their losses were by 7 at NCSt and by 21 at home vs BYU. Two weeks ago they beat Army 28-6 (-4). Tulane is 1-5 ATS as a home AAC double-digit favorite and EC is 15-5-1 ATS as a double-digit dog! Pirates will keep this game within single digits.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 10th

NORTH TEXAS by 3 over Usf - This is USF's first trip to Denton since '02. NT is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS while USF is 3-1 SU/ATS with wins over Boise St and Florida. N.Tex QB Drew Mestemacher has an 11-0 ratio and their offense is putting up 45 ppg/437 ypg and 105 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. USF avg 32 ppg/400 ypg and 100 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. USF has the edge on defense and the Bulls have played a much tougher schedule (#8 vs #122). NT has won their 3 home games by 38 ppg but two weeks ago they only led South Ala 28-22 and scored a late td. Both teams have been impressive so we are just giving NT a 3 point edge for being at home.

Fresno St by 2 over COLORADO ST - Fresno St making first trip to Fort Collins since 2016. Bulldogs won LY at home, 28-22, as 3pt fav. They were -79yds but led throughout and allowed td with 17 sec left to make gm appear closer. Fresno St has won 5 straight this ssn incl trips to Oregon St and Hawaii. However, they've lost last 2 ATS. LW vs Nevada (+13'), FSU raced out to 20-3 lead and had to hold on for 20-17 win. The D is stepping up but a sagging off is gaining 35 fewer yds than opp's average (#120 FBS). CSU has slipped to 1-4 SU & 2-3 ATS with the lone win over N. Colorado. D had been playing well but just allowed 540 yds and 45 pts to a SD St offense that entered Wk 6 in trouble. Rams will play better back at home and Fresno is not as good as its 5-1 mark. But CSU has too many issues on both sides of the ball and will lose a close one by 2.

WASHINGTON by 6 over Rutgers - 4th all-time meeting. Rutgers lost in '16 & '17, but won LY's home game, 21-18, as 1'-pt fav. Rutgers opened 3-0 then lost at home to Iowa 38-28 despite a 400-346 yd edge. In its last game, Rutgers had a 387-359 yd edge but fell to Minnesota 31-28 (-3'). QB Kalia-manis is hitting 67% with a 9-2 ratio and Raymond has taken over at RB and has 472 (5.4). Rutgers D has allowed 34.5 ppg in 2 B10 games, but is only allowing 347 ypg and held Iowa and Minny to 19 ypg below avg. Wash was 3-0 for its showdown with Ohio St but had its 22-game home win streak snapped, 24-6 (+9'). LW, UW rallied from a 20-0 4Q deficit to beat Maryland, 24-20 (-5'), for its 1st B10 road win. Fisch is 5-2 ATS as a HF here. Washington is playing a 4th str. wk while Rutgers is fresh off a bye. Rutgers is 15-6-1 ATS as an AD since Schiano returned! The home team is 13-3 SU in Washington games with Fisch. Last 9 games off bye week, Rutgers 8-0-1 ATS, and 15-6-1 as a AD!

SATURDAY OCTOBER 11th

CINCINNATI by 17 over Ucf - Schools have split 10 mtgs SU & ATS and home tm is 8-2 ATS in series. Cincinnati (+3') won in Orlando LY, 19-13. Bearcats never trailed despite being -59yds. Cincy has pulled b2b upsets over Kansas and #14 Iowa St to move to 4-1 SU & ATS while entering the Big 12 race. Offense is cooking behind QB Brendan Sorsby (12-1 ratio) and 300-yd rushers Tawee Walker & Evan Pryor. After tagging ISU with 474 yds, they're #16 in the FBS, gaining 149yds above opp defenses avg. UCF is going in the opposite direction after b2b SU & ATS losses to KSU and Kansas. The Jayhawks loss hurt LW because it was in Orlando and they led at HT before fading in the 2H. Cincy's playing at a much higher level right now, and UCF lacks the scoring punch (22.8 ppg vs FBS) to keep pace. Bearcats avoid the letdown spot and win by 17.

FAU by 7 over Uab - The home team is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series. UAB is 2-3 SU/ATS and they go from facing an option offense to a spread pass attack this week. FAU also comes in 2-3 SU/ATS. Last week they faced Rice's option offense and pulled a 27-21 (+4') upset. QB Veltkamp only has an 11-8 ratio but should have his best game against UAB's pass D which is ranked #135 (62%, 10-1). FAU is +51 ypg while UAB is -22 against identical sked strength. UAB QB Kitna is hitting 68% w/a 9-5 ratio and FAU is only #117 in our Pass D rankings (63%, 9-0). Trent Diller is 0-14 SU on the road and FAU had a misleading final at home 2 wks ago vs Memphis (trailed 31-26 4Q, lost 55-26). This should be a high scoring game and we have a small lean on the home favorite.

ARMY by 17 over Charlotte - First meeting. Charlotte faced the option 3 weeks ago on short rest and lost 28-17 (+2'). They allowed 255 rush (5.5). Army is 2-3 SU/ATS and with a tough remaining schedule this is a must-win to reach a bowl. Last week Army was outgained 362-295 against UAB but won 31-13 (-7). The Black Knights D is holding foes 168 ypg below their avg (#43 in FBS). Charlotte just allowed 407 rush (6.6) in a 54-26 loss to USF LW. The 49ers trailed 33-7 at half, outgained 397-63. They were actually covering (+27) until USF scored with :43 left. Charlotte gets an extra day to prep for the option and keeps it within 3 td's.

JAMES MADISON by 21 over Louisiana - First mtg. While Louisiana was enjoying a much-needed bye in Wk 6, JMU was getting pushed by Georgia St. Dukes were a 20pt fav, but trailed 7-0 in 3Q and needed a pair of 2H td's to escape, 14-7. The offense only had 285 yds in its worst effort of the yr. Still, they're 4-1 SU & ATS (2-0 at home) and the D is solid, holding opp's 161 yds below their avg (#10 FBS). Louisiana comes off the break 2-3 SU & ATS (0-2 on road). However, in their last gm they may have saved their ssn with a 54-51 defeat of Marshall. They also may have found an answer at QB in Lunch Winfield who came off the bench for 254 yds and 5 td's. However, the D has allowed 137 pts the last 3 gms and won't stop the JMU backs. Winfield faces a much tougher test here and the JMU offense will get back on track with a 3 td rout.

Old Dominion by 21 over MARSHALL - ODU 0-5 all-time at Marshall but has covered 3 straight. LTH in '23, Monarchs (+14') fell 41-35. Herd (-3) won LY in Norfolk 42-35. But this is Ricky Rahne's best tm, and ODU is playing like a serious SBC contender. Monarchs have only lost to Indiana by 13 and are 4-1 ATS. Plus, they're learning how to dismiss inferior opponents, pummeling Coastal Carolina (+20') LW 47-7. ODU had 619-189 edge in yds and is cranking out 179 yds above opposing defenses' avg (#5 FBS). Marshall was off LW and is back home for first time in a month. Herd is 2-3 SU & 3-2 ATS, splitting 2 home gms ATS. The offense has shown life with QB Carlos Del Rio-Wilson (78.5%, 9-0) and has averaged 44pts last 3 gms. At home and rested, Marshall keeps this competitive for a half, but ODU pulls away in 2H and wins by 3 td's.

App St by 5 over GEORGIA ST - As SBC foes, AppSt is 11-0 vs Georgia St (7-2-2 ATS & 5-0 ATS in Atlanta). Mountaineers moved above .500 with LW's 27-23 win over Oregon St (+1'). They jumped out to 17-0 lead but were -102 yds and had to hang on to beat winless Beavers. AppSt 2-3 ATS and 0-2 in true road gms. Georgia St's only win was over Murray St and they're 1-4 ATS. However, the losses were to Ole Miss, Memphis, and Vandy, and the cover came in LW's 14-7 loss to JMU (-20). D held the Dukes 125 yds below their avg and has played well when not facing SEC teams. AppSt finally protected the ball LW and has the right opponent to pick up a true road win. Mountaineers will feed RB Rashod Dubinion (513, 5.8) to remain perfect vs Georgia St.

PENN ST by 21 over Northwestern - Wildcats have lost 9 of last 11 in series. NW has covered 3 of last 5, including last 2 in Happy Valley. Penn State has won last 3 mtgs ('17,'22,'23), allowing 9 ppg in those. Lions have covered 7 of last 10. In last meeting, PS (-26') on the road broke a 10-10 HT tie with 4 2H TDs in a 41-13 win. LW, UCLA became the first 0-4 or worse team to beat a Top 10 team in 40 years when they held on for a 42-37 upset (+24') over Penn St. Northwestern did not look good in 1st road game, trailing Tulane 20-3 at half and were -5 in TO's. LW, Northwestern scored on 1st 3 poss en route to a 42-7 win over ULM (-13'). Penn St comes in with a 2-gm losing streak. They were 9-4 ATS at home the last 2 yrs but 0-4 ATS this yr with 2 last-scnd TD back-door covers. NW is 23-15 ATS as an AD. We see PSU bouncing back, winning by 21.

Clemson by 21 over BOSTON COLLEGE - Clemson has won the last 12 in this series. Last mtg was in '22 and Clemson won 31-3 (-20). After a 1-3 start and off a bye we knew Clemson was in for an A+ effort against a weak North Carolina team. NC led 35-3 at half w/a 367-78 yd edge, easily cashing a 3★ LPS as part of our 4-2 day. BC has lost 4 straight and LW they were outgained 331-69 and trailed Pitt 31-0 at half. Pitt's true fresh QB was making his first career start and shredded BC's D, throwing for 323 yards as BC lost 48-7 (+6). Now they face Cade Klubnik who has rebounded with B2B 300 pass yd efforts. Clemson has a huge edge on D here. Dabo Swinney just thumped an NFL HC legend and now he gets a lopsided win vs another former NFL HC. The buy light may have turned on with Clemson last week and we definitely are backing them here.

GEORGIA TECH by 20 over Virginia Tech - The visitor is 14-3 ATS in this series and the underdog is 14-3 ATS with 11 outright upsets! LY GT had a 356-233 yd edge but lost 21-6. GT is 5-0 SU and fresh off a bye but were fortunate to win 2 weeks ago at WF, 30-29 (-13). We thought VT turned their season around when they upset NCSt on the road. They were -6 against Wake Forest LW and put up just 263 yards in a 30-23 loss. GT is rested while Virginia Tech is playing their 7th straight week. Phillip Montgomery is 24-9 ATS as an away dog but we think VT's bubble burst last week in their poor performance. We are cautiously taking the Jackets laying the points.

WISCONSIN by 3 over Iowa - 99th battle for the Heartland Trophy. Iowa trails 49-47-2, but has won last 3 meetings and 4 of 5. Hawkeyes 5-1 ATS last 6, allowing 14 ppg. Last time here in '23, Iowa (+9) kept Wisconsin out of EZ in 15-6 win. Badgers have lost 3 straight to Iowa, but have won 3 of last 4 at home (2-2 ATS). Iowa is 3-2, with a 3-pt loss to undefeated Iowa St and 5-pt loss to undefeated Indiana. They are fresh off a bye which should help QB Gronowski (64%, 3-2), who was injured vs Hoosiers. Wisconsin opened 2-0 then lost at Alabama as expected and was upset at home by Maryland. LW, Wisconsin lost to Michigan 24-10 (+16) in Simmons' 1st st at QB. Wisconsin lost LY, 42-10, in Iowa City. Badgers are 49-19 at home the last 11 years SU, but just 9-8 under Fickell. Badgers run D is allowing just 75 ypg (2.9) and with Gronowski hurt we will take the Badgers D to shutdown the Hawkeyes and pull the upset.

MICHIGAN ST by 10 over UCLA - UCLA has won last 3 ('66 Rose Bowl, '73, '74). In last 6 road trips vs B10, Bruins 4-3 SU & 5-2 ATS (3-0 ATS LY in trips to diff times zones - Neb, Rut, PSU). UCLA 15-11 ATS on road s/20 (0-2 this year). Spartans played one former P12 team LY, losing at Oregon, 31-10, as 23-pt dog. Both teams had 2nd year HC's and figured to be much improved. Michigan St opened 3-0 SU but 0-3 ATS all at home. They got a late 75-ydTD pass for a back-door cover at USC, losing 45-31, then had a bye to get healthier. LW MSU lost to Nebraska 38-27 (+12). UCLA opened 0-3 SU and after an embarrassing home loss to New Mexico 35-10 fired HC Foster. They trailed Northwestern 17-0 but covered, losing 17-14. LW, UCLA became the first 0-4 or worse team to beat a Top 10 team in 40 years when they held on for a 42-37 upset (+24) over Penn St. MSU HC Smith was a great HF at Oregon St but is 0-7 as a HF here. Its time to snap that skid - Spartans by 10.

Ulm by 3 over COASTAL CAROLINA - First mtg since '22. While ULM has exceeded expectations, Coastal has been one of the SBC's underachievers. Chants weren't supposed to win the conf, but they also weren't supposed to be 2-3 SU & 1-4 ATS. And they're coming off a dreadful 47-7 loss to ODU (-20') in a gm every bit as lopsided as the score (-430 yds). The offense avgs 272 ypg (#132 FBS) & 13 ppg (#134). ULM, meanwhile, is 3-2 with the only losses to Bama & NW LW. Wins over UTEP and ArkSt are progress in HC Vincent's 2nd yr. This is on the road where the Warhawks struggle. But Coastal is in disarray so it's a rare winnable gm outside Monroe. ULM is an AF for first time since '19, but they'll seize this opening and keep the Chants reeling.

Miami, Oh by 7 over AKRON - RedHawks have won 7 straight in series (5-2 ATS, covered L/2). Last met in '23, Miami (-17) only led 10-0 HT & needing 4Q fg to cover 19-0 with just a 236-212 yd edge (off FD'd 14-11). Both started the season 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS before blowout wins over FCS foes & LW both won & covered over their MAC foes. Their only difference is Miami had a Bye, while Akron 2 wks ago ran into an angry Toledo off an upset loss & looking for revenge for LY's loss vs Akron. LW Miami QB Finn who was injured in 2Q vs UNLV returned after sitting out vs FCS foe. He hit 14-26-170-1-0 & rushed for 90 looking to be fully healthy. They trailed NIU 14-0 but scored the last 25 (-5). Zips (+7) gave us a Big Dog winner of button #9 of our comp line. Led by QB Finley (18-29-252-3-1) & RB Gant (32-176) Akron led CM 28-10 3Q holding on for a 28-22 win (417-374 yd edge). While Miami is the better team, Akron is 3-1 ATS L/4 and are getting DD, so take the pts.

Toledo by 7 over BOWLING GREEN - Battle for the I-75 Trophy. A hard fought Rivalry Toledo leads series 43-42-4. BG's first year HC Eddie George knows a thing or two about rivalry games. Both are off a bye. Toledo had won 9 straight in series (5-3-1 ATS) but they have split L/6 (BG 4-2 ATS). Visitor is 4-0 SU but BG has 3 straight covers all as dog with 2 outright upsets. LY BG (+2') never trailed but led just 28-26 mid-3Q before scoring L/13 for a 41-16 win. BG is 2-3 SU but opened ssn 4-0 ATS before losing to LY's MAC Champ Ohio 35-20 (+7). Toledo is also 4-1 ATS (3-2 SU) with a close loss to Kentucky & wins of 24+ vs WKU, Morgan St & Akron. Their only loss was as a 14 pt AD at WM, they led 13-0 but lost 14-13 giving up a td & 2 pt conversion w/52 left. BG has played tougher schedule (#72-127) and so in a close rivalry match-up, play the dog.

Northern Illinois by 3 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Huskies are 14-2 SU (won L/3) and 11-5 ATS. Last met in '23, EM (+12) led 13-10 4Q & it was 13-13 before allowing GW td with 1:11 left in 20-13 loss. Both teams come in with just one SU win (EM 2-4 ATS, NIU 1-4 ATS). Huskies have struggled on offense (#133 scoring FBS) as EM has the edge with our #97-#134 offense. Eagles have struggled on defense (#126 scoring FBS) with NIU having an even bigger edge with our #72-#135 defense. Huskies have held both Maryland (30 ppg) & San Diego St (28 ppg) to season lows of 20 & 6. While EM is usually a play on as a road dog going 31-14 '16 (just 1-3 TY) they are just 11-10-1 as a HD s/15 (1-0 TY). Eagles are also just 2-9 ATS hosting NIU so with such a small line look for the Huskies to continue their series road dominance.

TEXAS TECH by 20 over Kansas - Texas Tech leads series 23-2 and is 11-1 in Lubbock (covered 3 of last 4 mtgs). Red Raiders have climbed into top 10 with 5-0 SU & 4-1 ATS start. In b2b gms they handed Utah and Houston their first loss by 24pts. TT dominated Houston LW with +15 fd's and +285 yds. They're avg 187 yds above opposing defenses avg (#4) and holding opponents 148 yds below their avg (#16). Kansas rebounded from a tough home loss to Cincy in Week 5 by beating UCF in Orlando, 27-20. KU trailed at HT but outscored Knights 13-0 in 2H. Jalón Daniels (16-2) leads an offense that's gaining 123 yds above opposing D's avg (#28). But their D has failed vs better off's (595 yds to Mizzou/603 yds to Cincy) Jayhawk HC Leipold is 7-12 here as an AD. Both tms will put up pts, but TT has too much offense and wins by almost 3 td's.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 13 over Ball St - Both unexpectedly come in undefeated in MAC play (WM 2-0, BU 1-0). Both have comeback upset wins over 2 of the favorites to win the MAC. WM (+14) trailed Toledo 13-0 before pulling out a 14-13 win. LW Ball St (+14) trailed Ohio 14-0 before pulling out a 20-14 win. Broncos are playing their 7th straight week while Ball St had a bye 2 wks ago. Both teams have struggled on offense (WM #125-#130) but Broncos have a huge defensive edge (#61-#132) holding foes to 20.7 ppg while Cardinals are allowing 29.4 ppg despite WM playing a slightly tougher schedule (#57-66). After failing to cover vs Purdue Ball St has covered L/4 (2-2 SU). WM has won & covered L/3 going 5-1 ATS with their only non-cover vs then #9 Illinois. Both have been better than expected but we will ride the Broncos better defense here.

OLE MISS by 38 over Washington St - First meeting. Wazzou is making their first trip to SEC country since '13 when they lost at Auburn 31-24. Ole Miss is 5-0 and fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago they beat LSU 24-19 w/a 480-254 yard edge. QB Trinidad Chambliss has already led wins over Arkansas, Tulane and LSU. He has a 5-1 ratio and is their #2 rusher with 266 (5.3). The Rebels D is holding foes 63 ypg below their average and they are #3 in our Pass D rankings (52%, 4-3). Wazzou is also fresh off a bye and won at Colorado St 20-3 (+5) 2 weeks ago. Ole Miss has road games against Georgia and Oklahoma on deck but Lane Kiffin is on an 11-1 ATS run in non-conf games and they already beat Tulane by 35 who is better than this Wazzou team. Ole Miss by a lot! **Iowa St by 10 over COLORADO** - Longtime Big 8 rivals meet for first time as Big 12 foes. Colorado has won 13 of last 14 vs Iowa St in Boulder but last mtg in 2010. Cyclones' perfect ssn took detour with LW's 38-30 loss at Cincinnati (+3). ISU lost 2 starting DB's prior to kickoff and never led. They're 1-3 ATS last 4 gms and 0-2 on the road. However, HC Campbell is 29-15-1 ATS off SU loss and 6-2 last 2 yrs. Colorado slipped to 2-4 SU & ATS but has played its best 3 gms the last 3 wks. Buffs only lost to unbeaten BYU (-6'), 24-21, and fell to 4-1 TCU (-13'), 35-21. They were tied with the Frogs on the road in 4Q before allowing final 2 td's. Colorado is battle-tested with losses against GT and Houston as well. They'll hang with Iowa St before suffering another late collapse. Cyclones will play with urgency and continue Campbell's post-loss success.

UTAH by 10 over Arizona St - Former Pac-12 rivals meet for second time as Big 12 foes. ASU (+5') won last yr in Tempe, 27-19. Both tms coming off bye (Sun Devils 3-0 ATS after bye under HC Dillingham). ASU is 4-1 and has won b2b 3-point thrillers over Baylor and TCU. Their only loss came in non-conf to Miss St. The offense still misses Cam Skattebo but the D is picking up the slack, holding opp 157 yds below their avg (#8 FBS). Utah rebounded from its only loss to TT by pounding WVU, 48-14, before the break. Utes are 4-1 SU & ATS, and save for the TT loss they've been lights out on both sides of the ball. Devon Dampier (11-3 ratio and 258 rush yds) leads an offense avg 39ppg and the D is holding opp 107 yds below their avg (#21 FBS). Utah cannot afford to lose another conf. In a low-scoring gm, Utes will hold off ASU in Salt Lake City.

BOISE ST by 24 over New Mexico - Boise St is 13-1 all-time vs New Mexico. Broncos 5-1-1 ATS last 7 mtgs and the under is 5-1 last 6 (avg 48ppg). Boise is 3-2 SU & 3-1-1 ATS and looking to rebound from LW's 28-7 loss at Notre Dame (-21). Broncos led 7-6 just before HT but were outscored 22-0 from that point. On the blue turf, Boise 2-0 ATS by combined score of 98-28 and the D is holding opp 105 yds below their avg (#22 FBS). Plus, they're 13-2-1 ATS after SU loss! At 3-2 SU & ATS, New Mexico is beating preseason expectations. Lobos have wins over UCLA and NMSt and lost 17 to Michigan. In a winnable gm LW, though, they lost to SJSt and now hit the road in b2b gms. Lobo QB Jack Layne has just a 7-6 ratio, so Boise will stack the box to stop the backs. UNM is improved but this is a bad matchup for them. Broncos roll by more than 3 td's.

USC by 7 over Michigan - Teams have met in 8 Rose Bowls, but this is Michigan's 1st trip to the Coliseum since 1957 (UM 16-6 win). Wolverines made one West Coast trip last year, losing to Washington (+1'). 27-17. USC leads 6-5 (6-2 in Rose Bowl). Trojans never won in reg szn (lost '57, '58, '24). LY in Ann Arbor, USC (-4') rallied from 14-0 hole, took 24-20 lead, but TD w/ :37 left gave UM the upset win (+4'). USC was dominant early at 4-0, ranked and a TD road favorite vs an Illinois team that fell out of the top 10 and was off a big loss. They lost 34-32 on a last-play FG. Michigan only led New Mexico 27-17 4Q and then lost at Oklahoma. They unleashed QB Underwood vs. CMCh and won 63-3, then outtrucked the Huskers on the road 286-43 and won by 3. LW, Michigan beat Wisconsin at home, 24-10 (-16'). USC has 17 total sacks & should pressure the young QB. USC is 13-7 ATS as a HF, 6-1 as HF in last 7, so we're taking Trojans by a touchdown.

TEXAS ST by 7 over Troy - Texas St (-13') snapped Troy's 12-gm series win streak LY, 38-17. Bobcats look to make it 2 straight at home where they're 2-0 this yr. After a fast start, they've gone 0-2 SU & ATS vs FBS tms incl LW's shocking 31-30 loss at Arkansas St (+13'). Bobcats had 519 yds but gave up GW td with 7 sec left. The offense averages 35ppg and QB Brad Jackson (67.2%, 7-1, 303 rush) is an emerging star but the D is allowing 32ppg vs FBS opp. Troy's only losses are to Clemson and Memphis. Last 2 wks, they beat Buffalo (-5') on the road and outscored So Alabama (+1) 31-24. An underrated D has not allowed more than 28pts in a gm. Since '22, Troy is 10-4 ATS as a road dog. Trojans will go toe-to-toe with Texas St and fall by just 7.

TENNESSEE by 17 over Arkansas - Vols are out for revenge for LY's 19-14 (-14) loss in Fayetteville. Both teams are fresh off a bye. Ark have lost 3 straight which led to Sam Pittman's firing but they could easily be 4-1 if not for fumbled on their final drives of close losses at Ole Miss and Memphis. Bobby Petrino is back as Interim HC and cleaned out the defensive staff following their loss to Notre Dame where they allowed 56 points and 641 yards. The Hogs D is allowing 425 ypg and 32 ypg more than foes avg but the offense avg 515 ypg and 150 ypg more than their foes allow. Petrino is 13-15 ATS as an away dog in his FBS career. Hogs defensive issues won't get solved in a week and we expect Tennessee to pull away as Heupel is 22-11 as a DD favorite at Tennessee.

TEMPLE by 1 over over Navy

Temple over Navy - Navy is 5-0 SU/2-3 ATS and they've won 4 of the last 5 mtgs. LY Navy won 38-11 (-13). Navy's last 2 gms have come against triple option teams and now they face a Temple offense led by QB Evan Simon who has a 12-0 ratio. Temple is 4-1 ATS this season and their losses are against Oklahoma and Georgia Tech. The Owls trailed UTSA 14-3 at half last week. Simon threw 2 td passes in the 3Q and Hunter Smith had a 54 yd td run as Temple won 27-21 (+6). LW Blake Horvath threw for 339 yards, the 5th most ever by a Navy QB but Navy only beat Air Force 34-31 (-12). Temple DC Brian Smith saw the option twice last year at Rice and the Owls D held Navy to just 10 points and 140 rush in an upset win. Navy is #112 in our Pass D rankings and they've spent the last 2 weeks on nothing but option teams. KC Keeler is 7-2 as a home dog so we are calling for the Owls to pull their 2nd straight upset!

TEXAS A&M by 4 over Florida - The dog pulled 4 straight upsets in this series until LY when A&M won 33-20 (-3) in The Swamp. Aggies had a 488-301 yd edge in that game but that was before DJ Lagway took over. Nobody coaches better when their job is on the line like Billy Napier. Last week they ended a 3 game losing streak by upsetting Texas 29-21 (+7). The most shocking thing about that game has to be that Florida put up a season high 457 yards against one of the FBS' top defenses. Now they travel to face #5 A&M who just beat Miss St 31-9 w/a 479-219 yd edge. The Aggies only led that game 7-3 at half. Lagway threw for 298 and 2 td's LW. Napier is 14-8 as an AD while A&M is 5-13 ATS under Elko. Florida rattled off B2B upsets vs ranked tms LY and we wouldn't be shocked if the same happens here.

LSU by 14 over South Carolina - LSU has won the last 8 meetings but SC was the better team last year when they had a 17-0 2Q lead and an unnecessary penalty wiped out a Pick-6. LSU is off a bye after that 24-19 loss to Ole Miss. The Tigers offense is averaging just 322 ypg against 4 FBS foes. SC is also fresh off a bye and two weeks ago they got 2 defensive td's and beat KY 35-13 (-5). SC is only avg 309 ypg. LSU's D is holding foes 102 ypg below their avg while SC's is holding foes 100 ypg below their avg. LSU is 15-8 ATS in Death Valley under Brian Kelly and this is a night game so the crowd will be explosive. Expect LSU's offense to improve off the bye and LSU wins by 2 td's.

Ohio St by 10 over ILLINOIS - Buckeyes have won 8 straight over Illinois & 11 in a row in Champaign (3-5 ATS last 8). Last time here in '15, OSU (-17) won 28-3 & outgained Illini 440-261. Illini last win in series was '07 in Columbus. Illini went 5-1 ATS vs ranked teams LY. They defeated Purdue LW 43-27 (-7) and a bye on deck, so this is one of their top home games of the yr. Illinois was 10-3 LY - even beating defending NC Michigan at home - and is one of the most experienced teams in B10. They opened 3-0 and sit at 5-1 including a win over USC. Bielema is 7-4 ATS as DD underdogs. After beating 2 overmatched foes, Buckeyes passed their first road test, defeating Washington 24-6. LW, Ohio St dominated Minnesota at home, 42-3 (-23). Ohio St has a smothering defense and is holding foes to 246 ypg below their average (#1) and have 13 sacks. Illinois has not had a bye yet this season, but will muster the energy to put up a fight here and stay within the line.

SMU by 20 over Stanford - LY SMU won their first meeting as ACC members 40-10 (-16). SMU is 3-2 and had 4Q leads in both losses to Baylor and TCU. Stanford's QB Ben Gulbranson has improved his pass yards in all 5 starts. Prior to their bye Gulbranson threw for a career high 444 yards in a 30-29 (-3) win over SMU. The Mustangs have yet to play 4Q of good football and are now 0-5 ATS this season. Stanford is -153 ypg on the road and has already lost by 24 at BYU and 28 at Virginia. Last week SMU only beat Syracuse w/a backup QB 31-18 (-17) but they led that game 31-3 4Q and Cuse scored 15 points in the final 10 minutes. Look for SMU to get a big lead again and not let up this time, Mustangs by almost 3 td's.

Nebraska by 13 over MARYLAND - Huskers 2-1 all-time vs Maryland, losing last meeting, 13-10, in '23. In only trip to College Park in '19, Nebraska (-6) won 54-7. Nebraska QB Raiola is in his 2nd year and much improved, hitting 76% with an 11-1 ratio. Nebraska opened 3-0 SU getting past Cincinnati by 3. They lost at home to Michigan despite a 23-16 FD edge, as they were outtrushed 286-43. LW Nebraska defeated Michigan ST 38-27 (-12). MD opened 4-0 with 3 wins as DD favorites at home then a road upset of Wisconsin. They were leading the B10 in sacks with 16. LW Maryland blew a 20-0 3Q lead and lost to Washington, 24-20 (+5). MD can't run the ball (93, 3.3) and no one has thrown on Nebraska (#2 pass eff D). Rhule is just 2-8 SU on the road with the Huskers, but we love the matchup edge. Nebraska wins by nearly 2 td's.

Houston by 20 over OKLAHOMA ST - Houston's first trip to Stillwater since '09 (upset #5 OSU as 15'pt dog). Cougars looking to rebound from first loss. They were outclassed by TT, 35-11, and out-gained 552-267. Backup QB Zeon Chriss-Gremillion finished after Conner Weigman was injured. UH has lost last 2 gms ATS (TT/Oregon St). Fortunately, the Big 12's worst tm is next up. Since beating UT Martin, OSU has lost 4 str, fired its coach, and gone 1-3 ATS. Cowboys were stomped by Arizona LW, 41-13, and had just 7 fd's and 158 yds. It won't get easier vs a Houston D that's 4th in Big 12 ypg (4.6) and allows 17.6 ppg. Cougar HC Fritz is 15-8 as an AF & 35-21 ATS off SU loss in his career while OKSt is on a 2-12 ATS run. He'll lean on his D to suffocate OSU and get back on a winning track.

UTSA by 21 over Rice - UTSA won 8 straight in this series from '15-'23 until LY when Rice pulled a 29-27 (+3) upset. UTSA has won the last 5 home meetings by 18 ppg. The Roadrunners are off to a disappointing 2-3 start and just lost at Temple 27-23 though they did have a 14-3 lead at half. Rice is 3-3 and lost 27-21 at FAU last week. Rice does have road wins over Louisiana and Charlotte but Jeff Traylor is 30-5 SU at home. RB Robert Henry leads the AAC with 666 (8.3). Rice's offense is putting up just 313 ypg and 122 ypg less than their opponents allow on avg. Jeff Traylor is 17-9 ATS off a SU loss. UTSA has pl'y'd the much tougher sked (#43 vs #118). Roadrunners get revenge on the Owls and win by 3 td's.

TCU by 3 over KANSAS ST - KSU has won 5 of last 6 mtgs incl '22 Big 12 CG in OT. These Wildcats won't be competing for a title, and bowl eligibility might be a longshot. They slipped to 2-4 SU & ATS with LW's crushing 35-34 loss at Baylor. KSU played well enough to win, gaining ssn-high 501 yds, but were unable to close. Their 2 covers came in last 2 wks, so the team does not appear to have quit on HC Klieman. At 4-1, TCU is still a Big 12 contender. Frogs' only loss was by 3 at ASU in Week 4. They struggled to shake Colorado (+13') LW but scored 21's in final 5:44 to grab win and front-door cover. TCU has avg 2.5 ypc last 3 gms, forcing QB Josh Hoover (15-4 ratio) into an even bigger role. We believe the bubble burst on KSU's disappointing ssn with LW's loss at Baylor. With more to play for, TCU will take advantage and escape Manhattan with a 3pt win.

NOTRE DAME by 28 over NC State - Series is tied 2-2 but Notre Dame has won & covered L/2. Last met in '23, ND (-7) never trailed but led just 24-17 into 4Q. They pulled away leading 45-17 before allowing a late td to win 45-24. Despite losing at Miami to start the season the Irish are on a 18-3 run ATS vs ACC. NC State opened 3-0 (2-1 ATS) before dropping 2 straight SU & ATS. They took their frustrations out LW beating FCS Campbell 56-10 (-42). The Irish started the season with two heartbreaking losses giving up GW fg w/1:04 left vs now #2 Miami & GW td w/1:13 vs now #10 TT. With no room for any slip-ups they have won & covered L/3 incl two as 20+ favorites. They have

the edges on both offense (#4-49) and defense (#9-#75) despite playing the much tougher schedule (#1-#68). After watching Penn St & Texas fall out of the Top #25, look for the Irish to show no mercy here as now #16 ND gained 5 spots this week & needs to impress.

OREGON by 11 over Indiana - One meeting since '64. Since '20, Hoosiers 2-6 ATS coming out of bye. Indiana won LY's West Coast trip over UCLA (+3), 42-13. IU 13-17 ATS vs Top 10 opp but wall-poled Illinois 63-10 this year. Ducks had won 14 straight over B10 (9-5 ATS) before LY's Rose Bowl loss to OSU and have not lost a B10 regular season game 11-0 SU! Oregon is 5-0 and, in its last game, went into Happy Valley White-out and won in two OT's, 30-27. QB Moore is hitting 75% with a 14-1 ratio. Indiana is 5-0 and as mentioned beat Illinois 63-10 at home and survived at Iowa 20-15. QB Fernando Mendoza is hitting 73% with a 16-1 ratio. Off bye, Ducks 3-1 SU & ATS under HC Lanning and he is 22-1 SU at home. LY Indiana had 2 games vs Top 10 teams on the road, losing to Ohio St 38-15 and Notre Dame 27-17. They are more talented this year, so we are taking the Ducks by DD.

Wake Forest by 1 over OREGON ST - Demon Deacons make the long trip across country for the teams first meeting. Beavers come in 0-6 SU & 1-5 ATS. They did lead Fresno St in 4Q and only trailed 29-27 before giving up IR td w/0:04. OSU(+13') led Houston 24-10 4Q but lost in OT 27-24 for their only ATS win. Wake Forest is 3-2 SU & ATS and coming off an upset 30-23 win (+6) over Virginia Tech. While WF has a bye on deck they then face SMU, FSU & Virginia the 3 next weeks so this game is important for bowl eligibility (last bowl '22). Wake Forest has the defensive edge (#55-#74), whole OSU has the offensive edge (#70-#86) despite playing the much tougher schedule (#3-#86). OSU has an FCS foe on deck. Beavers are a home dog but their only ATS win was their only other game in that role, so we will look for them to get at least their 2nd ATS win.

Air Force by 3 over UNLV - AF has won 3 straight and 5 of the last 6 in Vegas. At 1-4 SU & 2-3 ATS, Falcons opt to worst start since '17. The offense has scored at least 30 pts in every gm and has really taken flight under QB Liam Szarka (13 tot td's). But this might be HC Calhoun's worst D. AF is dead last in Pass Eff D and is giving up 38ppg. Last wk at Navy (-12'), Falcons allowed 3 td's of 50+ yds in 34-31 loss. On the opposite spectrum, UNLV is 5-0 for first-yr HC Mullen. However, the Rebs have yet to play an opp with a winning record and they struggled with Idaho St & Miami (OH). Every opp gained more than their avg against the UNLV D which is struggling to stop the run (MWC-worst 5.2 ypc). In '17, AF started 1-4 and ended the slide by topping UNLV. We expect the same result here, with the AF offense sparking an upset and exposing the Rebs.

HAWAII by 4 over Utah St - Since 2011, Utah St 8-0 SU & 7-1 ATS vs Hawaii. Last yr in Logan, Aggies (+2) gained 580 yds and hammered Warriors, 55-10. First-yr HC Bronco Mendenhall has already positively impacted Utah St. Aggies are 3-2 SU and 5-0 ATS, winning their first MWC gm over Air Force and covering against Texas A&M & Vandy. QB Bryson Barnes (11-1 ratio) leads an offense averaging 36ppg despite facing 2 SEC tms. Hawaii is 4-2 with losses to Arizona and Fresno St. Under HC Chang, Warriors are 6-2-1 as a home favorite. And with QB Micah Alejado healthy again, they gained ssn-high 535 yds in a 44-35 win at AF before last wk's bye. Utah St is improved under Mendenhall and they'll put up points again this week. But so will Hawaii which is an outstanding home team. Warriors win a close shootout to end Aggies' series dominance.

San Jose St by 3 over WYOMING - As MWC members, SJ St is 6-1 SU & 4-3 ATS vs Wyoming. LTH in '22, Spartans (-2) were +203 yds in 33-16 win. SJ St 2-3 SU & ATS this ssn but is coming off their 2 best gms. In Wk 5, they lost in the final 19 sec to Stanford (-3), 30-29, and LW they ended New Mexico's 3-gm win streak, 35-28, as 2'pt fav. QB Walker Eget is heating up with a 7-0 ratio last 3 wks and WR Danny Scudero leads FBS in rec & rec yds. Meanwhile, Wyoming is skidding. Cowboys have lost 3 straight (0-3 ATS) and the offense is gaining 64 less yds than opposing D's average (#123 FBS). In a snowstorm LW vs UNLV (plays indoors), they were +101 yds but allowed 2 blocked punt ret td's in 31-17 loss. Wyoming usually has a big home-field edge in Laramie, but HC Sawvel is 2-7 SU. SJ St has the coaching edge and momentum to win here by 3.

MINNESOTA by 13 over Purdue - Purdue has won B2B games in series after going 1-8 SU from '12 to '21. Last time here in '22, Boilers (+9) held Minnesota to season-low 47 rush yds in 20-10 upset but that was with Jeff Brohm as HC and Odum is the 2nd coach since then. Since '14, Purdue 25-10 ATS as conf road dog (2-3 LY). Three of last 4 and 4 of last 6 were won by dog ('23 gm was PK). Purdue has been much more competitive this yr, winning their first 2 handily, then covering at home vs USC (33-17 loss) and only trailed ND 35-23 at half. LW, Purdue fell to Illinois, 43-27. QB Browne is hitting 63% with a 6-5 ratio. Minnesota opened 3-1 SU but 1-3 ATS. They only beat Rutgers by 3 at home in a game they were outgained 243-145 at half. LW, Minnesota was on the wrong end of a 42-3 blowout vs. Ohio St. Fleck is 11-7 ATS as a HF the last 4 years, so we are taking the Gophers.

Georgia by 7 over AUBURN - UGA is 17-3 SU in this series and they've won the last 7 mtgs by 16.6 ppg though Aub did cover the last 2. Aub is fresh off a bye following 2 straight road losses. They were outgained 414-177 & out FD'd 21-9 at A&M but only lost 16-10 (+6). Auburn's Oline has allowed 15 sacks in their last 2 games. UGA was off the loss to Bama last week. They led KY 35-7 and allowed a td with 1:51 left. The Dawgs already have a win at Tennessee. Auburn wasn't nearly as close as the score suggested against A&M while Georgia continues to get better each week. Kirby Smart was 19-7 as an AF his first 8 years and just 1-7 since but this line sits at just a fg and UGA owns the series.

San Diego St by 11 over NEVADA - Nevada won last mtg in '23, 6-0, as 11'pt dog but SD St won LTH in '22, 23-17, laying 7. Aztecs are trending north. They're 3-0 SU & ATS last 3 wks incl a 34-0 blanking of Cal. The D has been the calling card, allowing a MWC low 12.6 ppg but Sean Lewis' offense perked up last week with 540 yds in a 45-24 rout of Colorado St. If the offense catches up with the D, SD St is a threat to win the conf. Nevada is 1-4 SU & 2-3 ATS (0-2 ATS in Reno) in HC Choate's 2nd ssn. The offense avgs just 15 ppg and is gaining 63 yds less than opp defenses avg (#121 FBS). Pack did get a spark in LW's 20-17 loss to Fresno St (-13') from true frosh QB Carter Jones who led 2 td drives and was 11-15-121-2. Jones is the future but he'll face a much tougher test this wk. Plus, the SD St offense is improving. Aztecs win on the road by DD.

4★ LAS VEGAS over Tennessee – TEN's offense is stuck in neutral (14.6 PPG, 233.8 YPG; 85.2 rush/148.6 pass) and now faces an LV front that can dictate with RB Ashton Jeanty (14-67 rush, 5-42 rec LW) against a defense allowing the 3rd-most rush yards and the most RB rush TDs to RBs. The scoring/yardage profiles tilt home: TEN's D is leaking 28.2 PAPG on 366.8 YPG, while LV can live in manageable down-and-distance (112.6 rush YPG) and marry play-action to keep Geno clean after a turnover-heavy LW. Trends reinforce the setup—TEN 0-7 ATS vs losing teams; LV 4-1-1 ATS after scoring <15—and TEN's lone win LW required a bone head ARI fumble in the endzone before scoring and then an INT turned fumble, turned TD. TEN RB Spears coming off IR is still getting eased back into action(4-14yds LW) and Bowers (knee, day-to-day) is LV's main watch, but even with TEN 2-0 SU/ATS in the recent H2H, the current form and trench edge point to sustained LV control indoors. Expect this to be the game everyone is talking about Jeanty as they roll TEN. **FORECAST: Las Vegas by 14**

3★ PITTSBURGH over Cleveland – CLE's road profile is rough (0-7 SU/ATS away; 1-7 ATS off a SU loss) and the offense remains capped despite Quinshon Judkins' 110 rush yards LW: Dillon Gabriel went just 3/11 on throws 10+ yds, with 12 of his 19 completions coming inside 5 yds, which stalled drives (14.6 PPG, 288.2 YPG). PIT comes off a bye (4-0 SU/ATS) and tends to start fast (#6 1Q scoring), while Aaron Rodgers' quick-trigger game should neutralize CLE's pass rush enough to sustain possessions against a defense allowing 24.6 PAPG. Venue trends also lean black-and-gold (CLE 0-4 SU/ATS at PIT in recent meetings). Rodgers is syncing with DK Metcalf, and in his 3 GB starts vs CLE he posted 708 yds, 9 TD, 0 INT — a matchup history that supports the edge. **FORECAST: Pittsburgh by 13.**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ TAMPA BAY over San Francisco – With SF's QB room banged up (Purdy toe setback; Mac Jones knee) and the ground game coming off <90 rush yds (CMC 22-57), the trend bite is real (SF 1-8 ATS after <90 rush yds). TB's offense is rolling (Mayfield 29/33, 379-2 TD LW; Egubaka 7-163-1) and even minus Evans the volume funnels cleanly to Godwin/Egbuka, while Rachaad White (2 rush TD LW) steadies the red-zone script. Numbers back the side: TB 27.0 PPG vs SF 21.2, Bucs 6-1 ATS after 350+ total yds, and a defense that's #1 in 1Q points allowed (0.0) to set tone at home. SF is on B2B road trips being 2-2 ATS in those, and TB's balanced profile plus situational edges point to separation late. **FORECAST: Tampa Bay by 10.**

Philadelphia Eagles vs NEW YORK GIANTS — TNF — PHI has dominated the matchup (7-1 SU, 5-3 ATS) and carries strong road form (7-1 ATS last 8 away), while the profile points to a slower game: PHI 25.0 PPG on just 261.6 YPG and the Under 4-1 for PHI vs losing teams. Barkley's "homecoming" angle matters—he gashed NYG last year (10.4 YPC vs this opponent)—but NYG still offers a path if they lean on the run (117.0 rush YPG) and clean up giveaways after five turnovers LW; injuries to Tyrone Tracy (shoulder) and Malik Nabers (ACL) thin the explosive threats. The Giants' defense has leaked yards (377.2 YPG allowed), yet PHI's OL must rebound after 6 sacks allowed LW; if they do, sustained drives and red-zone chances tilt their way, while a more methodical pace keeps total points in check.

Denver by 10 over New York Jets - Early London Game - DEN brings the cleaner profile to Tottenham (355.2 YPG, 16.8 PAPG) with a pass rush that just logged 6 sacks vs PHI, while the run game (140.6 rush YPG) supports Bo Nix's rhythm throws (Courtland Sutton 8-99 LW). NYJ's counter is clear—lean on Breece Hall (14-113 LW) and they #1 4Q scoring, although garbage time will do that. HC Glenn's D has been lackluster at best, they're the first team in NFL history with zero takeaways through five games and sit dead last at -8 TO margin. With DEN 5-1 ATS vs losing teams and NYJ 2-10 ATS vs winning records, the turnover and protection gaps tilt sustained chances toward DEN, even if a late NYJ push keeps the finish lively.

INDIANAPOLIS by 10 over Arizona — IND has been rock-solid at home (3-0 SU/ATS TY; 2-0 SU/ATS in B2B home spots) with a clear profile gap in points and yards (+12.0 PPG; 381.2 YPG vs ARI 288.4). Coming off a 40-6 rout, IND's balance showed (Taylor 17-66-3; Jones 212-2-0; DEF 4 sacks/2 INT), while ARI just blew a 21-3 lead despite Tyler's 289-3-0 and now loses RB Trey Benson (IR). Historical nudge favors IND (8-1 ATS after allowing <15), though ARI's been pesky on the road (6-0 ATS vs winning home records); also notable is IND's kicker change with Spencer Shrader out for the season and could impact things. Overall IND offense is humming and ARI is still trying to figure out what happened LW. Daniel Jones and the IND offense should have no problem in this one.

LA Rams by 10 over BALTIMORE — LAR are perfect traveling chalk (AF 5-0 SU/ATS) and just stacked 456 total yards with Stafford at 389-3-0, while the offense averages 401.8 YPG (289.6 pass). BALTIMORE's defense has cratered (35.4 PAPG, 408.8 YPG allowed) and with Lamar out, Rush threw 3 INT and the unit mustered 207 yards; as a dog they're 0-3 SU/ATS and only 1-3 ATS in back-to-back home spots. Trend tape favors the visitor (LAR 5-0 ATS off a SU loss; BAL 0-4 ATS after <90 rush yds), and this is a rare big HD ask for BALTIMORE (haven't been >+7 since 2021).

Seattle by 3 over JACKSONVILLE — SEA's road form (8-0 SU, 6-2 ATS) travels, and the offense just hung 463 yds at TB with Darnold a hyper-efficient 28/34 for 341 and 4 TD while taking 0 sacks. The numbers lean to a modest overall edge built on passing efficiency (SEA ~245 pass YPG into a JAX defense allowing ~250) plus a run-game matchup where SEA's front (83.0 rush YPG allowed) is built to blunt JAX's 137.0 rush YPG and force longer third downs. JAX is 4-0 ATS at home and comes off a statement win over KC despite being outgained by 146 yds, orchestrated by Etienne's 2 rush TD, a 99-yd INT return and the stumble-rooski Lawrence GW TD. — a reminder they can flip games with splash plays. If that turnover/hidden-yardage magnet swings back toward even, SEA's steadier scoring/yardage profile (29.2 PPG, 358.4 YPG) and explosives to JSN/DK are enough to eke out a one-score road result.

Dallas by 7 over CAROLINA — DAL just ripped a 30-0 run on NYJ to start the game behind Dak (18/29, 237, 4 TD) and 5 sacks, and their #1 2Q scoring vs CAR's #31 2Q scoring allowed points to a quick separation script again. The numbers still lean DAL on volume (+91 YPG season-to-date: 406.6 vs 315.0), even with CAR's defense holding opponents to 311.6 YPG and Dowdle erupting for 206 rush yds LW. Trends are mixed (DALAF 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS; CAR 7-1 ATS at home), but CAR off a win has been a fade (1-8 SU, 3-6 ATS), and Dallas has covered five straight after 150+ rush yds (hit 416 total yds, 135 on the ground LW). Injury ledger matters: DAL is still without CeeDee/Turpin, yet the pass game spread it around (Flournoy 6-114) while the front generated heat and CAR likely down TE Sanders again. Something to watch here is DAL is on B2B away games while CAR is on B2B home games but DAL is the stronger team here.

LA Chargers by 4 over MIAMI — The season profile tilts LAC: +73 YPG on offense (352.2 vs 278.6) and a big defensive edge with nearly 93 fewer YPG allowed (293.8 vs 386.6), plus 7-1 ATS vs the AFC and AF 4-2 SU/ATS. LW Herbert was muted (166-1-1) behind 5 sacks, but MIAMI just surrendered 239 rush yds in a blowout 17-0 start and is 1-5 ATS after allowing 150+ rush yds. With Tyreek Hill (knee) out for the year even as Tua/Waddle stayed efficient (256 and a TD), LAC's 19.6 PAPG defense and LY's rebound trend after B2B losses (2-0 SU/ATS) line up with a one-score road result.

New England by 3 over NEW ORLEANS — NE returns to an AF role (3-1 SU/ATS) off the BUF upset where Maye went 22/30 for 273 with 0 TO and RB Stevenson punched in two. Both are in B2B spots: NE in B2B away (1-5 SU, 3-3 ATS) and NO in B2B home (1-3 SU/ATS), with the Saints also 0-5 SU (1-4 ATS) as a HD. Taysom Hill's return adds QB-run/TE wrinkles, but NO needed five straight NYG giveaways and still settled for four FGs last week, while their D has allowed 27.0 PAPG. Edges lean NE to grind out a one-score road result.

GREEN BAY by 14 over Cincinnati — GB off the bye (4-1 SU last five) brings a balanced 114.5 rush / 232.8 pass into Lambeau where they're 5-1 ATS, attacking a CIN defense giving up 31.2 PPG and 391.2 YPG. Jordan Love draws a secondary that just let Jared Goff toss 3 TDs from clean pockets, while EDGE Micah Parsons (2.5 sacks TY) keys pressure on a Bengals offense stuck at 17.0 PPG and 57.0 rush YPG. QB Update: CIN trading for CLE Joe Flacco should lift the passing floor—his CLE numbers were dragged down by league-worst WR separation, constant heat (73 QB pressures), and no run game (84.8 rush YPG); now he gets an elite WR room with Chase/Higgins to actually push the ball. Note GB's lone rare big-fav of -14+ this decade delivered a 34-0 smashing in 2024 vs NO, another sign the Packers can pour it on at home against this struggling team. It's probably too soon for Flacco and CIN to turn things around so quickly but there will likely be wow moments TW to make you optimistic for NW if you're a CIN fan.

Detroit Lions vs KANSAS CITY CHIEFS — SNF — DET rolls in hot after a fourth straight win, with Jared Goff dealing (19/23, 258, 3 TD) and the defense snagging three first-half INTs to set the tone vs CIN. KC just piled up 476 yards (Mahomes 318 pass, 60 rush; Kelce 7-61-1) and logged 3 sacks in a tight finish with JAX. Trends cut both ways: DET is 4-0 ATS vs teams with losing records and 4-1 SU/ATS in B2B road spots, while KC is 4-0 SU (3-1 ATS) off a Monday game. The recent series is even (1-1 SU last 7 years) with DET 2-0 ATS in those two. Even the total angles split—Over 4-1 in DET's last five road games vs Under 6-1 for KC after an ATS loss—setting up a primetime matchup where both offenses can land punches.

Buffalo Bills vs ATLANTA FALCONS — MNF — BUF comes in off a 23-20 loss despite 371 yards and 4 sacks, still profiling as a high-output offense (30.6 PPG, 395.8 YPG; 154.4 rush YPG) with Josh Allen-to-Kincaid humming (6-108 LW). ATL returns from the bye (3-1 ATS off a bye) with a run-forward identity (136.5 rush YPG) and a defense that's kept points reasonable (21.5 PAPG). Situationally, BUF has answered well after shaky pass-defense weeks (5-1 ATS after allowing 250+ pass yards), while ATL has struggled to stack ATS wins (3-12 ATS after an ATS win). Pace, turnovers (BUF had 3 LW), and whether ATL can control clock on the ground inside the dome feel like the swing factors here.

Chicago Bears vs WASHINGTON COMMANDERS — MNF — WAS gets QB Jayden Daniels back under center (231-1-0, 39 rush yds LW) and leaned on the run (156.4 rush YPG) plus a five-sack defense to rip off 27 straight in their win; they've also cashed 5-0 ATS in their last five at home. CHI comes off a bye (2-1 ATS in that spot) with a 25.2 PPG offense and a chance to steady things if they clean up a run D allowing 164.5 rush YPG. Matchup keys feel binary: can WAS' ground game and 20.2 PAPG defense control script, or does CHI's balanced 328.0 YPG attack and fresh legs flip it late? Trends tug both ways on totals (CHI Over 4-1 off an ATS win vs. Under 5-1 on the road vs. winning home teams), setting up a tight, physical primetime look.
