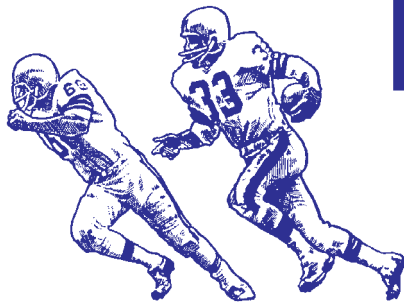

SC is 3-4 SU/ATS as they lack punch on offense (20 ppg/298 ypg). QB Sellers has a 5-2 ratio and has just 108 (1.3) rushing. They've allowed 26 sacks including 11 in their L2 games. Since losing their opener Bama has won 6 straight though some of the covers weren't comfortable (late td vs Vandy & push vs Mizou). They've won b2b road gms behind a solid D and improving offense that's scored at least 44 in consecutive gms for first time since 2016. RB Lucky Sutton & WR Jordan Napier both have more than 500yds of offense. D is giving up just 12ppg and team is +106ppg. Fresno St is 5-2 SU but 3-4 ATS with 2 straight ATS losses. They're 3-0 at home but 0-3 ATS in MWC gms. Before break, Bulldogs suffered worst loss of the yr. They outgained Colorado St 469-334 but were -4 TOs and fell 49-21 (SDSt beat CSU 45-24). 2★ Michigan over MICHIGAN ST - Mich leads series 74-38-5. Since '16, UM is 6-3 SU (incl L/3) & 4-5 ATS. In last 3, UM is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS and allowed just 24 total points. Last time here in '23, Michigan (-24') outgained MSU 477-182 in 49-0 rout (1st shutout since '00). LY in Ann Arbor, MSU controlled TOP & outgained Mich for 1st time since '15, but lost 24-17. MSU opened 3-0 SU but 0-3 ATS, then scored late for backdoor covers against USC, Nebraska and Indiana. They were then pummeled at home 38-13 by a resurgent UCLA. LW, MSU Mich St got a back-door cover with a FG with :30 left, but Indiana won, 38-13 (-26). QB Chiles is hitting 65% with a 10-3 ratio. Michigan lost at Oklahoma in QB Underwood's first road start then beat Nebraska on the road 30-27. LW, Michigan picked off UW QB Williams (who came in with 1 int) 3 times in a 5-pass span, cashing a 2★ on these pages, winning 24-7 (-4). Underwood is hitting 62% with a 7-2 ratio. DELAWARE by 4 over Middle Tennessee - Delaware won the only two prior mtgs back in 1977-78. MT is 1-5 SU/2-4 ATS. They are 0-2 in CUSA play and just lost at home to Missouri St but did cover as 2' point dogs, losing on a late fg. Delaware started the season 3-1 and won their CUSA opener at FIU. They've lost 2 straight but had yard edges over both WKU and Jax State. LW they trailed 38-12 at Jax St then went 65/8 and 95/8 td's for a misleading 38-25 final. The Blue Hens are +52 ypg while MT is -58. MT's QB Vattiano has an 8-4 ratio while Delaware's Minicucci has a 9-3 ratio. MT did win at Nevada and had a 126 yd edge at Kennesaw. Blue Hens are laying over a td which seems like a lot for FBS' newest member. **NEW MEXICO ST by 7 over Missouri St** - First meeting. NMSt is 3-3 SU/ATS and they've won all 3 of their home games including wins over Tulsa and Sam Houston. The Aggies are -81 ypg on the road but +1 at home and none of those road games were against P4's. Missouri St is 3-3 SU/ATS. They are 2-1 SU/1-2 ATS on the road but their 2 road wins are by a combined 3 points at Marshall and Middle Tenn. The Bears are +5 ypg at home but -59 on the road. NMSt ran for a season high 146 (3.8) LW at Liberty in their 30-27 (+11) loss. They had a 388-293 yd edge. NMSt's QB Fife has an 8-4 ratio. Missouri St trailed in the 4Q of both of their road wins. Sanchez needs this one bad for their first bowl berth so we like the home team by a touchdown.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 23RD

South Alabama at GEORGIA ST - Georgia St has won 3 straight mtgs (3-0 ATS) and last 3 at home, but this is the first mtg since 2020. Both schools reeling at 1-6 with the lone win over FCS opp. However, South Alabama has been more competitive. Jaguars just -6ppg and -14ypg and lost by 2 to Tulane, 16 to Auburn, 14 to North Texas and 7 to Troy. FRIDAY OCTOBER 24TH

North Texas by 24 over CHARLOTTE - CLT won both games vs NT in '19 & '20 as members of CUSA. NT is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS this year and are coming off a 55-17 (-4) win over UTSA. QB Mesta-maker now has a 17-3 ratio. NT ran for a ssn high 270 yards including 133 from RB Hawkins. Tim Albin was better off staying at Ohio. The 49ers are now 1-6 SU/2-4-1 ATS and they are -124 ypg while NT is +100. All 6 of CLT's losses have been by double-digits including LW when they lost 49-14 (+11') at home vs Temple but yards were only 384-357. NT is 2-7 ATS as a double-digit AF and the 26' points is the most they've laid on the road since '18. Short rest favors the underdog and NT could be putting some time in to defend the option this week.

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VIRGINIA TECH by 7 over California - Whoever made the ACC schedule did Cal no favors here. The Bears travel across country to play in Blacksburg on short rest and VT is fresh off a bye. Cal is one of 8 teams that have 0 or 1 loss in ACC play. The Bears two ACC wins are against BC and UNC by a combined 7 points and they needed a fumble on the goal line to beat the Tar Heels. VT is 2-5 SU/1-6 ATS but they are only -14 ypg against our #45 sked. Cal is +20 ypg but -51 vs the ACC and they've only ply'd our #85 sked. QB JKS has been turnover prone (7 int's), was w/o his top receiver LW and took some big hits and even left the game briefly. You couldn't find a better situation for VT so we are taking the Hokies by a touchdown.

Boise St by 24 over NEVADA - Boise has won 8 of last 9 in series (6-3 ATS) but only won 28-21 at home last yr as 23' point fav. Even with 2 losses (at USF & at ND), Broncos holding out hope of winning MWC and returning to CFP. They'll need to win out and get help, notably from the Bulls. Boise moved in the right direction with last wk's 56-31 demolition of previously unbeaten UNLV. Broncos gaining 59 more ypg than opp avg (#36 FBS) and holding foes 93 ypg below their norm (#21 FBS). However, on the road they're 1-2 ATS and just +3ypg. Under HC Danielson, Boise 10-2-1 ATS vs MWC. After going 3-10 LY, Nevada is still rebuilding under Jeff Choate. Pack 1-6 SU & 3-4 ATS, and they've lost 14 straight MWC gms. Nevada has competed in its last 2 road gms (3 pt loss at Fresno and 2 pt loss at New Mexico) but they're 0-3 ATS in Reno. This is a bad spot for an offense that's been under 300yds for 3 straight gms and gains 65 less ypg than opp D's avg (#123 FBS). Boise coasts by more than 3 td's.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 25TH

UConn by 7 over RICE - UConn is 2-0 SU vs Rice with both wins coming by 7 points. Last year UConn had a 309-178 yd edge and won 17-10 (-7). Rice is in the first year of running the triple option. They started 3-1 but have lost 3 straight and they were crushed 61-13 (+9') at UTSA prior to their bye. UConn has won 4 straight and a win here makes them bowl eligible. They are off a win over BC, 38-23 (-1). QB Joe Fagnano has a 15-0 ratio and RB Cam Edwards has rushed for 694 (6.1). The Huskies run D is allowing 160 (4.0) but they haven't faced the option since '22 when they lost 34-17 at Army. Rice has the situation edge with UConn coming off a win over a regional ACC foe and Rice will run the game and limit possessions. Just like the last two meetings, we have UConn by a td.

BUFFALO by 7 over Akron - Bulls have won 7 straight (6-1 ATS) vs Zips but Visitor has covered 4 straight. LY Akron (+1) trailed 38-7 into 4Q but got within 38-30 w/4:39 left before losing 41-30 despite a 452-390 yd edge. LW UB (-15) trailed UMass 21-17 into 4Q needing a td w/19 to pull out a 28-20 win. UB HC Lembo emphasizes Spec Tms & UB has a huge edge (#19-127) & LW Akron pulled within 35-28 vs Ball St but then allowed a 90 yd KR td & lost 42-28. Bulls also have a big edge on defense (#93-#126). Zips are 1-3 SU & ATS in MAC play being outscored by an avg 32-16. Buffalo is 3-0 SU in MAC play but is 0-3 ATS only winning by a combined 11 pts despite being a Fav of 9+ in all 3. With UB's inability to pull away take the scrappy Zips & the points here.

CINCINNATI by 3 over Baylor - This is just the 2nd mtg between these schools. Baylor (+3) won, 32-29, on the road in '23. Alongside BYU, the other tm unbeaten in conf play, Cincinnati has been the Big 12's biggest surprise. Since losing to Nebraska, the Bearcats have won 6 straight and are 5-2 ATS. Led by QB Brendan Sorsby (17-1 ratio), the offense has been terrific, gaining 73 ypg above the opp's avg (#28 FBS). However, the D allows opp to gain 54 ypg above their norm (#111 FBS). Plus, Cincy has played the softest portion of their Big 12 slate so there's still a lot to learn about this team in the second half. Baylor is Cincinnati light -- offense has averaged 43ppg in 3 road trips but the D allows 77ypg more than the opp avg (#122 FBS). The big difference is Baylor has played a tougher schedule and fell to 4-3 with last week's 42-36 loss at TCU. Cincy will come back to the pack, but not this week. Bearcats win a high-scoring game over a Baylor team that could face a motivation gap after suffering a second Big 12 loss.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 18 over UMass - Chippewas have won & covered both prior mtgs but last met in 2013. CM is 4-3 SU & ATS incl 2-1 SU & ATS in MAC play winning by an avg 24-16. UMass is 0-7 SU (2-5 ATS) incl an FCS loss. Minutemen have been outscored by an avg 37-9 vs FBS foes (30-10 in MAC play) as they last in the FBS in Total Off (249 ypg) & scoring (11.3). LW CM (+3') led BG 17-6 at HT & scored 10 unanswered in 2H despite being outgained 310-276. LW Minutemen (+15) actually led LW 14-3 2Q & 21-20 into 4Q before allowing GW td w/19 in a 28-20 loss. CM has the edges on Off (#116-136), Def (#90-#134) & ST (#110-133). UMass is 1-2 ATS in road games being outscored by an avg 37 ppg. CM is 2-0 SU & ATS at home winning by 25 ppg. UMass is on their longest trip in MAC play, look for the Chippewas to take care of business here

Tcu by 20 over WEST VIRGINIA - WVU has won 5 of last 6 mtgs and road tm has won 3 straight in series. TCU moved to 5-2 SU & 4-3 ATS with last wk's pivotal 42-36 home win over Baylor. Frogs led throughout and allowed 2 scores in final 3:08 to make the gm appear more competitive. TCU has a bye next wk before the stretch run. They're 4-0 in Fort Worth but have dropped b2b road gms vs ASU and KSU. Frogs' strength is the passing gm, where Josh Hoover is tied for the FBS lead with 21 td passes. If not for Oklahoma St, WVU would be this year's worst Big 12 tm. Since beating Pitt Week 3, 2-5 'Neers have lost 4 in a row by at least 2 td's (1-3 ATS). The D allowed 43ppg over that stretch and the depleted QB room has a combined 4-6 ratio. WVU is back home, which helps, and TCU is playing a 6th cons wk. But WVU's 100th ranked pass D won't stop Hoover, and the Mountaineers lack the scoring punch to keep pace once TCU starts humming.

GEORGIA TECH by 13 over Syracuse - GT is now 7-0 and ranked #7, their highest since 2009, which is also the last year they won the ACC. LY GT was 2-0 but were two weeks off a trip to Dublin and lost 31-28 (-3) at Syracuse. The Jackets were outgained 515-378. LW GT was outgained 238-110 in the 1H but was tied 7-7. They controlled the 2H and pulled the upset 27-18 (+3') which cashed a 3★ LPS for us. Since losing QB Angeli Cuse has lost to Duke 38-3, trailed SMU 31-3 and LW lost to Pitt 33-13 (+10). QB Rickie Collins has already thrown 8 int's and his completion% (53.2%) and ypa (5.5) are significantly less than what Angeli was giving them. Brent Key only has 1 ACC win by more than 15 points and he is 7-14-1 as a HF. GT is laying just over 17 points and they've yet to get that kind of distance consistently so we are taking the points here.

INDIANA by 28 over UCLA - In their 1st-ever meeting LY, Indiana (-3') traveled to UCLA and picked up an easy 42-13 road win. In 6 trips to diff time zones the last 2 years, the Bruins are 4-4 SU & 6-2 ATS, with 3 outright upsets. UCLA opened 0-3 and, after a 35-10 home loss to New Mexico, they fired their HC. Under Tim Skipper, the Bruins won the next 3 ATS, including a monumental upset of Penn St and a road rout of Mich St. LW, UCLA won its 3rd straight, 20-17 (-4), while handing Maryland its 3rd loss in a row by a total of 10 pts. QB lamaleava is hitting 65% with a 10-5 ratio and is the team's leading rusher (360, 4.9). The Hoosiers opened a perfect 6-0 SU and 4-2 ATS with huge wins over top 10 teams Illinois (63-10) and at #3 Oregon (30-20). QB Mendoza is hitting 73.5% with a 21-2 ratio. LW, Mich St got a back-door cover with a FG with :30 left, but the Hoosiers won, 38-13 (-26). As a road dog since '20, UCLA 11-5 ATS. Indiana 10-3 ATS at home under HC Cignetti. While UCLA is a great story this year, they run into a buzz-saw this week.

LOUISVILLE by 28 over Boston College - The home team has covered 5 straight series meetings and BC is 6-2 ATS. BC has lost all 6 games vs FBS foes and they are -93 ypg vs FBS foes. The Eagles are on an 0-5 ATS run. LW they switched to Duke transfer QB Grayson James. The Eagles led 20-17 at half but were outgained 249-123 in the 2H and lost 38-23 (+1). UL gets extra rest after upsetting Miami last Friday. The Cardinals have a big edge on D here, allowing just 274 ypg and holding foes 123 ypg below their avg. BC is allowing 397 ypg and they are allowing 64 ypg more than their foes avg. UL has played the tougher sked (#30 vs #56). UL is 0-7 ATS as a HF in conf play but these two are going in complete opposite directions so we would much rather lay 25' points here with the home team.

MIAMI, FL by 27 over Stanford - First meeting. UM had their annual hiccup last week, losing 24-21 (-14) at home vs L'ville. Carson Beck threw 4 int's and UM only ran for 63 yards (2.6). Stanford pulled the upset LW against FSU despite getting outgained 444-293 and FSU finished the game on the SU1. QB Gulbranson was carted off field w/a knee injury and Elijah Brown hit 6-12 for 71 yards in the 2H. Brown could be making his first career start vs an angry Miami team. UM is +72 ypg vs FBS foes and the 'Canes are 7-1 ATS as a HF vs FBS foes L2Y. SU is 9-24 ATS as away dogs since '17 including 0-4 ATS this year and they are -119 ypg on the road while UM is +155. 'Canes are laying over 4 td's here and while the angles say to take Miami, this is a lot of points to lay and Stanford has been improving. **Virginia by 7 over NORTH CAROLINA** - NC has won 3 of the L4 mtgs but UVA is 6-2 ATS in the series. The dog is 5-1 with 4 outright upsets. NC was on the door steps of their first ACC win LW but they fumbled at the goal line and lost 21-18 (+10) at Cal. Gio Lopez got the start and threw for 167 yards. UVA was off a bye and were -17 against Wash St. They trailed 20-10 4Q and won the game on a safety following a botched KO return by Wash St. UVA's loss to NCSt is considered a non-conf game so UVA is 3-0 in ACC play. The 'Hoos offense avg 462 ypg but only put up 237 and 301 in their L2. The dog owns this series and UVA had 3 straight close wins. We won't call for the upset but prefer to take the points.

PITTSBURGH by 13 over NC State - NCSt has won the L3 meetings but they haven't met since the '20 Covid season. Pitt is 3-0 SU/ATS since switching to Frosh QB Mason Heintschell. LW they were -11 at Cuse. Pitt only finished with 260 yards but won 30-13 in a sloppy game. NCSt comes in 4-3 SU/3-4 ATS. They are fresh off a bye and 2 weeks ago put up just 7 points and 233 yds in a 29 pt loss at Notre Dame. RB Smothers is #1 in the ACC with 739 (6.6). Pitt's D allows just 82 rush ypg (2.5) and they have 19 sacks but could be w/o both starting LB's including AA Kyle Louis. Pitt has a huge ST's edge and they are on a 6-2 ATS run as HF while NCSt is 10-18 as an AD. Panthers could be 7-0 if they didn't blow two leads vs WVU and L'ville and we think they control this game.

PURDUE by 3 over Rutgers - Rutgers has won outright upsets over Purdue in both meetings ('17 & '20). Last time here in '20, Knights (+11) overcame 10-pt HT deficit to rally for 37-30 win. Purdue has a new HC in Barry Odom but they were just 1-10 SU to the home the previous two years. Purdue has been a much improved team this yr, beating Ball St and So Illinois, then playing solid vs USC, ND and Illinois. LW, Purdue lost to Northwestern, 19-0 (+3) - the Wildcats' 4th straight win. Purdue QB Browne was 5-10-31 before leaving with shoulder injury in 2H. Browne is hitting 60% with a 7-7 ratio. Rutgers opened 3-0 then blew a 4Q lead vs Iowa, had a yardage edge at half vs Minny but lost and led Washington at half but lost, 38-19. LW, Rutgers was destroyed by Oregon, 56-10 (+18'). This year they are led by QB Kaliaiakanis (62% 11-5), but the D is allowing 57 ypg above opp avg. Schiano is a solid 12-16 SU on the road since returning to Rutgers.

Ohio by 12 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Bobcats are 9-1 SU & 8-2 ATS vs Eagles but their have been 3 outright upsets L4 mtgs. LY Ohio (-11) led 21-7 into 4Q in a 35-10 win finishing with a 433-266 yd edge. EM is playing 9th straight week (bye on deck) while Ohio had a bye 2 wks ago. Ohio is 2-1 SU & ATS in MAC play but that loss was their only MAC road game losing 20-14 at Ball St as a 14 pt AD. EM is 1-3 SU & 2-2 ATS in MAC play but won & covered their only MAC HG (+2) beating NIU 16-10 despite being outgained 310-296 (TO even). LW Ohio (-11) also beat NIU 48-21 at home finishing with a 538-293 yd edge (TO even). Bobcats put up 332 rush yds (6.4 ypc) vs NIU LW & avg avg 214 ypg & 5.2 ypc. EM is allowing 253 ypg (6.0 ypc). Ohio has edges on both Off (#63-92) & Def (#95-132). With points for both, if you must take EM & the points.

Bowling Green by 4 over KENT STATE - Flashes are 5-2 SU & 4-2-1 ATS vs BG but lost the L/2 (0-1-1 ATS). LY BG (-21) led just 10-3 into 2Q & 20-6 HT before scoring only pts of 2H w/6:32 left for the 27-6 push. BG are 5-2 ATS & 4-3 SU incl 1-2 SU & ATS in MAC play. In their only MAC win 2 wks ago without QB Pine (foot inj, unknown status) BG (+10) trailed rival Toledo 21-0 2Q before a 45 yd td pass w/13:20. Down 21-14 into 4Q, BG got a trick RB pass 75 yd td (21-21) & a strip sack to set up a 1 yd td drive (28-21). BG took a final play safety to seal a 28-23 upset despite being outgained 429-226. LW Kent St (+24) led Toledo 10-0 & only trailed 17-10 HT but lost 45-10 being outgained 552-224. LW BG (-3) trailed CM 17-6 HT & lost 27-6 despite a 310-276 yd edge. KSU has played tougher schedule (#50-74) & are 1-1 SU & 2-0 ATS in MAC HG. BG lost (0-1 ATS) their only MAC AG. Look for a scrappy KS to keep it within the line.

MIAMI, OH by 27 over Western Michigan - Broncos are 8-1 SU & 5-3 ATS in series but MU (-8) won last mtg in '23 come in tied at top of MAC standings with UB at 3-0. Both opened 0-3 SU (MU 1-2, WM 2-1 ATS) but come in winning & covering 4 straight. WM has played tougher schedule (#100-121). Miami is playing 6th straight week (bye on deck) while WM off bye but has rival CM on deck. Redhawks are on a 25-5 SU run at home incl 16-5 ATS vs MAC. WM is 11-6-1 ATS in MAC road gms (1-3 LY, 1-0 TY). WM is outscoring MAC foes by an avg 26-5 outgaining them by 168 ypg. MU is outscoring MAC foes 30-17 outgaining them by 103 ypg. WM QB Lowry is avg 142 ypg (65%) w/5-1 ratio & is their top rusher (476, 5.1, 7 td). MU QB Finn is avg 166 ypg (57%) w/6-5 ratio & is the top rusher (332, 4.7 3 td). This is a balanced game on paper but Miami has the edge of 12th yr Miami HC Martin (WM 3rd yr HC Taylor) and is on a 7-1 ATS run as a MAC HF.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 4 over Ball St - Cardinals are 5-1 SU & 4-2 ATS vs Huskies with 5 outright upsets L4 incl 4 straight. LY Ball St (+12') led 19-7 2Q but NIU hit a 47 yd fg w/15 left to go up 23-22. Cardinals with 2 time-outs went 39 yds and hit a 52 yd FG w/0:02. TY NIU has struggled on Off (#2 lowest 12.3 ppg) is 1-6 SU & ATS losing L/5 SU & ATS. Ball St is 3-4 SU & 5-2 ATS but in their only other MAC road gm lost 42-0 (+9) at WM. Huskies are a surprising favorite here but are coming off a season high 21 pts on Off and were in RZ but gave up a 91 yd FR td. Ball St beat Ohio 20-14 with a 357-356 yd edge while NIU (+10) lost 48-21 (outgained 538-293). Ball St has 2 outright upsets TY vs Ohio (+14) & LW vs Akron (+1) and could get a 3rd here.

NEBRASKA by 6 over Northwestern - NW has dropped last 3 in Lincoln, but is 6-1 ATS last 7 trips to Nebraska. LTH in '21 was the lone ATS loss in the stretch. 'Cats allowed season highs pts (56) and yds (657) in 56-7 loss. Since joining B10 in '12, Nebraska is 7-5 SU (4-8 ATS) vs NW. Last 13 meetings have been decided by avg of 9 points, with 10 decided by 8 pts or less. NW opened with a disappointing loss to Tulane 23-3 (-5 TO) and was 1-2 after a back-door cover vs Oregon. The Cats ended the James Franklin tenure at Penn St with a 22-21 upset. LW, NW won its 4th straight game, 19-0 over Purdue (-3). QB Stone hit just 11-26-132 but NW ran 50-232. Stone has had a 10-7 ratio. Nebraska opened 5-1 with close wins over Cincy, Mich St and Maryland and were outmuscled by Michigan (outrushed 286-43). LW, Minn defeated Neb 24-6 (+6'), sacking QB Raiola 9 times and holding Huskers without a TD in a loss for 1st time since '16. Nebraska lost two starting OL in 1H. Cats are 24-15 ATS as AD the last 11 years and Huskers 16-20-1 ATS as HF the last 9 years.

ARKANSAS by 7 over Auburn - Aub is 7-2 SU/6-3 ATS in this series since '16 but Ark has won 2 of the last 3 including LY 24-14 (+2'). The home team is 1-5 SU/0-6 ATS and the Over has hit 9 of the last 11. Ark has been a hard luck team, with 4 close losses, all vs ranked teams and they are +70 ypg. Petrino's squad put up 527 yards LW against A&M. QB Green (1910 pass, 17-5, 589 rush, 7.1) would be a Heisman contender if they had won some of those games. Aub has lost 4 straight, also all against ranked teams but the Tigers are -65 ypg in those. QB Arnold has a 5-1 ratio but avg an SEC worst 6.1 ypa. Aub has given up 28 sacks including 5 LW in their 23-17 2OT loss to Mizzou. Both teams could be better than their record. Ark has the better offense while Aub has the better D. A loss here will probably be the end of Hugh Freeze in Auburn. Petrino's squad still has some fight in them and they get the win.

OLD DOMINION by 10 over Appalachian St - App St leads series 4-1 with only loss coming in last visit to Norfolk in '23. Both tms looking to rebound from tough losses. ODU coming off b2b road collapses at Marshall, 48-24, and JMU. JMU game was supposed to be a battle of SBC favs but Monarchs lost, 63-27, and were outgained 624-285! This is still the tm that beat VT by 19 in Blacksburg and suddenly resurgent Coastal Carolina by 40. They're 3-0 at home, winning by an average margin of 34pts and 339 yards, but last in FBS with 18 TO's. Off b2b wins over Oregon St and Georgia St, App St was hitting its stride at 4-2. But last wk, they played their worst gm in a month and lost to Coastal 45-37. Yards were even and Mountaineers led 4Q, but they allowed ssn-high 246 rush and 2 td's in final 3:10 to lose at home. App St 1-2 SU & ATS on the road. Back in Norfolk and facing an App St D coming off its 3 worst gms, ODU gets back on track with DD win.

IOWA by 13 over Minnesota - Floyd of Rosedale Trophy on the line for 119th time. Minn has lost prior 10 at Iowa (2-7-1 ATS). Iowa 11-2 SU (9-3-1 ATS) since '12. Hawkeyes have won 5 straight & 10 of 11 at home (lost in '23). LY, Kaleb Johnson rushed for 206 yards to lead Iowa past Minn on the road. Iowa opened 4-2 with a 3-pt loss to Iowa St, a 5-pt loss to Indiana and 4 wins as a favorite. LW, Penn St started backup QB Grunkemeyer but lost to the Hawkeyes, 25-24 (-3'). QB Gronowski is hitting 65% with a 3-4 ratio with team-best 10 rushing TDs. Minnesota also opened 4-2 with a losses to Ohio St and on the road vs Cal. LW, Minnesota sacked Nebraska QB Raiola 9 times. Nebraska was held without a TD in a loss for 1st time since 2016, as Gophers won 26-46 (+6').

KANSAS by 6 over Kansas St - 123rd Sunflower Showdown. Kansas St has won 16 in a row (11-5 ATS). Kansas (+9) did cover last time in Lawrence in 31-27 loss. Both tms off bye (KU 5 straight wins & covers off bye/KSU 1-6 ATS last 7 after bye). Jayhawks have not been favored in this series since '09. Kansas 4-3 and 3-1 at home with the lone loss to 6-1 Cincy by 3. This is their first game back home in their newly renovated stadium in a month. KSU 0-3 outside Manhattan but they have covered 3 straight over UCF, Baylor and TCU. Kansas' offense gains 68ypg above opp avg (#33 FBS) and Jalon Daniels has been the better QB with an 18-2 ratio and 231 rush yds. But KSU has the better D, especially vs the run (3.9 ypc vs 5.1ypc). This will be an emotional, seessaw gm that comes down to the QB's. With one final shot to beat KSU, Daniels will deliver in the clutch to beat a Wildcat team that's 0-4 this year in one-score games with FBS teams.

SOUTHERN MISS by 24 over Ulm - Southern Miss won last mtg in '23, 24-7, as 3pt fav. These teams are going in opposite directions in October. Southern Miss has won 3 straight for new HC Huff and at 5-2 (3-0 SBC) they sit atop the West Division. Braylon Braxton has a 14-4 ratio and the defense is tied for the league lead with 21 sacks. This was a different team when it last played at home a month ago, so there'll be a lot of excitement in Hattiesburg. ULM, on the other hand, has faded since starting 3-1. Warhawks have been blown out last 3 gms by an average score of 34-10 by Northwestern, Coastal Carolina & Troy. The offense gains 67 ypg less than opp average (#124 FBS) while the D allows 79ypg more than the opp average (#125 FBS). With a bye looming next week, Southern Miss will play fast and loose in front of the home crowd. ULM has also been sloppy with the ball (-5 TO margin) which will create short fields in a USM run by more than 3 td's.

NEW MEXICO by 6 over Utah St - Utah St 4-0 SU & 3-1 last 4 trips to Albuquerque, but New Mexico won LY and has covered 2 straight. Aggie HC Mendenhall is facing the team he coached in '24. He knows many of the Lobo players, however those kids would like to send a message since he bolted to another MWC program. Utah St beat San Jose St last week to move to 4-3 (0-3 on the road). However, the defense has allowed more than 500 yds the last 3 games and yields 68 ypg more than the opponents average (#119 FBS). New Mexico is 3-4 overall and 3-0 at home (1-2 ATS). Lobos covered against Michigan and upset UCLA, but the team has been killed by turnovers (FBS-worst turnover margin of -12). Their deep backfield will keep the chains moving against a Utah St D that's 11th in the MWC in run defense. Plus, the Lobos will play with a little extra intensity to show Mendenhall is a bad career choice to leave UNM after just one year.

Winners of 4 straight, Troy is one of the SBC's hottest tms and tied atop the West with Southern Miss at 3-0. For the first time in 3 wks, they're back home where they're 2-1 SU & 1-2 ATS. The offense has perked up with an avg of 39ppg over the last 3 and the D has 19 sacks and just used 4 TO's to beat ULM 37-14 despite being -12 yds. At 2-5, Louisiana is off to its worst start of the HC Desormeaux era. However, during a recent 3-gm stretch with some of the league's better tms, Cajuns beat Marshall, and only lost to JMU and USM by an avg of 11pts. D gives up 51 more ypg than opp avg, but has improved over the last 2 wks despite absence of sacks. Troy has momentum and the return home is a big edge, but the Trojans are 13-17 ATS as a HF the 7 yrs and UL is better than their record so this should be a close game!

UTAH by 17 over Colorado - Utah wants payback for last yr's 49-24 loss in Boulder that snapped 7-game series win streak. It was the Utes' worst loss in the series since 1955. Colorado will get to Salt Lake City with a situational edge. While Buffs are off a bye, Utah is coming down from an emotional loss to BYU (Utes 1-3 SU & 0-4 ATS week after Holy War incl LY vs Colorado). Buffs 3-4 and 0-2 on the road. However, they've played better in October than September incl 3-1 ATS last 4. HC Sanders is 6-2 ATS as a DD dog. Utah slipped to 5-2 with the 24-21 loss to BYU. Still, they were +102 yds and just a wk earlier crushed Arizona ST 42-10. Utes gaining 133 ypg above opp average (#8 FBS) and holding tms 101 ypg below their norm (#16 FBS). Utah could be w/o QB Dampier this week which means they would start rFr Ficklin. While it won't get that lopsided at Rice-Eccles, Utah will get back revenge for LY's Boulder beatdown but the QB situation has us concerned.

Texas by 3 over MISSISSIPPI ST - Texas' playoff hopes were nearly ended LW when they needed OT to beat KY. LY Texas was -34' but only won 35-13. Since covering that game, MSU is 11-3-1 ATS. LW the Bulldogs put a scare in Florida, losing 23-21 (+9). MSU is 0-3 SU/1-1-1 ATS and -111 ypg vs SEC foes. Texas lost to that same Florida squad a few weeks ago. The Longhorns are -96 ypg vs SEC foes and LW they were outgained 395-179 by Kentucky! MSU has a home win over Arizona ST and nearly beat Tennessee at home yet they are getting 7 points from a Texas team that has played one good game against a quality foe. We can't find many reasons to lay points on the road with Texas so we are ringing Cowbell for this game.

Texas A&M by 3 over LSU - LSU was 11-0 ATS in this series from '10-'21 but A&M won & covered 2 of the L/3. The home team is 8-0 SU in this series. A&M 7-0 SU but only 3-4 ATS. They led 45-35 LW at Ark (-7) but allowed a td with :10 left. A&M allowed a season high 527 yards including 268 rush (8.4). LSU was the underdog vs Vandy for the first time since 1948 LW. The Tigers never led in the 2H and lost 31-24 (+1). LSU has won their last 6 home games including wins over SCar & FL this year but the Tigers are -62 ypg and they were outgained by FL and scored late to cover vs SCar. A&M is +141 ypg vs the SEC. Marcel Reed has a 15-4 ratio and WR Mario Craver leads the SEC with 668 (19.1). Garrett Nussmeier only has an 8-5 ratio vs FBS foes and LSU is putting up 2 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. LSU is 23-2 SU at home and 8-3-1 as a home dog while A&M is 5-12 SU on the road. A&M is the better team but it's tough to go against LSU in Death Valley.

Temple by 14 over TULSA - KC Keeler has done a great job turning Temple around in his first year. The Owls are 4-3 and need this game badly if they want to be bowl eligible. Temple is 6-1 ATS this year including 4 straight covers. LW they crushed Charlotte 49-14 (-11). Tulsa also has a 1st year HC but they've lost 3 straight since their upset win over OKSt. They are -154 ypg vs AAC foes though they have faced 4 of the AAC's better tms (Tulane, Navy, EC & Memphis). Temple QB Evan Simon has a 16-0 ratio. The Owls have already won more road games (2) than they did from '20-'24 (1-26 SU on the road). Keeler is 8-2 as an AF. Temple is +14 ppg in AAC play which is where we put this line.

VANDERBILT by 7 over Missouri - LY Vandy was off a loss to Georgia St. The 'Dores were +18' and nearly pulled the upset, missing 3 fg's including in OT and lost 30-27 in 2OT's. 'Dores are 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS and +143 ypg. LW They beat outrushed LSU 239-100 and won 31-24 (-1). Mizzou is 6-1 SU/4-2-1 ATS and +227 ypg but Vandy has faced the tougher sked (#54 vs #71). LW Auburn missed 3 fg's and Mizzou won 23-17 (-1). RB Hardy has been held to 36-110 the last 2 weeks and Vandy's run D is allowing just 92 (3.4). Mizzou fans won't overrun Firstbank Stadium the way LSU fans did last week. Vandy is 2-0 SU/ATS in revenge spots this year and we think they cash a 3rd.

IOWA ST by 6 over Byu - BYU 0-5 all-time vs Iowa St, losing the most recent mtg in 2023, 45-13, as a 7 pt dog. Cougars have impressively navigated 7 gms to remain one of the 5 FBS teams without a loss and one of 2 without a Big 12 loss. They're +20ppg and +144 ypg but those numbers drop to +7 and +66 in conf play as BYU has won 4 gms by 6 or less. This is a situational spot that favors Iowa St. While the Cougars are coming off an emotional Holy War win over Utah, the 5-2 Cyclones got a bye wk to recharge and rebound from b2b road losses to Cincinnati and Colorado. It also gave much-needed time to coach up young DBs taking on a bigger role in a bang-up secondary. Iowa St is 3-0 in Ames including wins over Iowa and Arizona, and the Rocco Becht-led offense stepped it up with 906 yds over the last 2 games. BYU has flirted with danger since Big 12 play began. Iowa St is poised to make them pay and hand them their first loss of the year.

Usf by 3 over MEMPHIS - Big AAC showdown that lost some draw after Memphis lost to UAB last week. USF's only blemish this year is a week 3 loss at Miami, which was their 3rd straight vs a ranked foe. They've won 4 straight and are +240 ypg in AAC play. QB Brown has a 16-5 ratio and is their #1 rusher with 475 (4.8). Memphis had covered every game prior to LW and UAB got the Interim HC Bump last week which is 5-0 ATS this year so we aren't throwing the Tigers in the trash yet. They were w/o QB Lewis who is a ? for this game as well. HC Silverfield is 31-6 SU at home including an upset win over Arkansas this year. If Lewis plays we could see them pulling the upset but USF is playing too well to make a play against.

OREGON by 41 over Wisconsin - Badgers' 1st trip to Oregon since '01 (lost 31-28). LY the Badgers (+13') led #1 Ducks in 4Q, but allowed final 10 pts in 16-13 loss (held Oregon to its fewest pts LY). After losing 1st 3 in series, Oregon has won last 4 (incl '12 & '20 Rose Bowls) to take 4-3 all-time series lead. Wisconsin opened 2-0 but then lost to Bama followed by losing their last winnable game to Maryland at home. For the 3rd straight year, HC Fickel lost his starting QB in the early weeks and are down to #3 QB Simmons. LW Ohio St QB Sayin hit 36-42-393 & Wisconsin has not scored a TD since its 1st drive vs Michigan and suffered a 2nd straight shutout loss, 34-0 (-24). Oregon was #2 in the country at 5-0 after its big win at Penn St but lost to Indiana at home. LW Oregon extended the nations longest road win streak to 10 with plenty of Duck fans on hand at Rutgers, 56-10 (-18). Wisc just 3-8 ATS as AD and, off Michigan, Iowa and Ohio St, how much do they have left in the tank? Lanning is 14-8 ATS as a HF and Oregon has a bye on deck.

TEXAS TECH by 45 over Oklahoma St - Texas Tech won LY in Stillwater, 56-48, for just their 3rd win in the last 15 mtgs. Oklahoma St has historical edge but that won't mean anything Saturday in Lubbock. At 1-6 SU & ATS, Cowboys are playing out the string. They're -25 ppg and -199 ypg in Big 12 play with last 3 losses by at least 3 td's. Now they have to travel for just the 2nd time since WK

2 to play an ornery Red Raider squad coming off its first loss. Tech played its worst game of the yr, losing at Arizona ST, 26-22, and gaining a ssn-low 276 yds. They were without QB Behren Morton who rested a knee injury. With or without Morton, they'll roll on offense. Will Hammond has played quality and has a 4-2 ratio. He's also 3rd with 231 rush yds (9.6, 4 td's) and his legs are an added wrinkle for OSU to defend. The league's top D will stifle a Cowboy offense gaining 46 ypg below foes average (#115 FBS). With something to prove, TT will rebound quickly and not let up.

Illinois by 3 over WASHINGTON - 1st meeting as B10 foes, and 1st meeting since '14 (Illini +13 lost in Seattle, 44-19). Huskies have won 4 straight ('71,'72,'13,'14). Only home loss in '51. LY, Wash was 6-0 SU at home and 5-1 ATS LY under Fisch winning by 13 ppg at home and 0-5 losing by 16 ppg on the road. Wash opened a solid 5-1 this yr with only a 24-6 home loss to Ohio St. LW Wash lost to Michigan, 24-7 (+4). They have a potent offense led by QB Williams (72%, 10-4, 363 rush), RB Coleman (568, 5.1) and WR Boston (515, 15.1). Illinois is 5-2 and still a playoff contender. They have the most veteran team in the B10 and beat Duke on the road 45-19, and USC at home. The losses were not pretty, but were to 2 of the top 3 teams in the country - 63-10 to Indiana and 34-16 to Ohio St. QB Altmyer is hitting 72% with a 13-1 ratio. Illinois is the 4th team in 5 weeks to be off a bye facing UW and this is the Huskies 6th straight week of playing. Under HC Bielema since '21, Illinois is 17-5 ATS in road games, including 6 outright upsets as a road dog.

ARIZONA ST by 7 over Houston - Two schools coming off big wins look to stay hot in Tempe. This is their first mtg since 1990 Coca Cola Bowl in Tokyo. Arizona St rose up last wk to hand Texas Tech its first loss, 26-22. Sun Devils held Red Raiders 268 yds below their season average, a year-long theme that's helped them remain alive in the Big 12. For the ssn, ASU is holding opponents 160 ypg below their average (#3 FBS!). They're 13th in the FBS with 21 sacks and #2 in the league in run D at 110 ppg. Since '21, Sun Devils 13-6-1 ATS in conf home gms. Houston held off Arizona last wk, 31-28, and also has just 1 Big 12 loss. They're 6-1 overall & 5-2 ATS with the only loss to Texas Tech. The offense averages 29 ppg and 24 ypg above foes average (#63 FBS). Cougars lack the playmakers to stretch the underrated ASU D. Sun Devils' top weapon Jordyn Tyson is nursing a hammy, so we expect points to come at a premium in a low-scoring ASU win.

NAVY by 10 over Fau - FAU is 0-2 against Navy but they haven't met since '17. The Owls did face Rice's triple option earlier this year and won 27-21 (+4). LW FAU was outgained 522-312 and lost at USF 48-13 (+21). Navy is fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago Temple put up 518 yards including 345 passing and Navy needed a 51 yd td run in the final minute and a 2 pt conv to win 32-31 (-10). QB Veltkamp has a 15-10 ratio but Navy's Pass D is #123 (236 ypg, 64%, 11-6). FAU is getting over 2 td's and they have backdoor potential in a high scoring game here so we lean with the underdog Owls.

Toledo by 3 over WASHINGTON ST - First mtg. Rockets are 4-3 SU & 5-2 ATS. While their opening loss vs KY was not a surprise (won ATS) their other 2 losses were. UT led both 13-0 (-14) vs WM but lost on a 2 pt conv 14-13 & 21-0 (-10) over rival BG but lost 28-23. Rockets are 2-1 SU & 3-0 ATS in non-conf play incl a 45-21 (-7) win over WKU. Cougars are 3-4 SU & 4-3 ATS but are 1-2 ATS at home. Toledo has the edges on Off (#58-98), Def (#37-53) & ST (#37-107). Cougars have played a much tougher schedule, and while we usually favor a team with that edge WSU the last 2 weeks traveled to play #4 Miss losing 24-21 (+32) returned home then flew to play #18 Virginia losing 22-20 (+17) then returned home. After two long trip, maximum effort losses WSU is tired and looking for a relaxing non-P4 foe. Also facing two Top 25 teams can also mean a lot of bruises that won't have time to heal fully here. Toledo is one of the top non-P4 and last year beat up Miss ST 41-17 (+10). We will take the points here and will call for the outright upset.

ARKANSAS ST by 3 over Georgia Southern - First mtg since '21 and Ark St's first visit from Georgia Southern since '19. Red Wolves opened 1-4 but have climbed back into the bowl picture with b2b 1-pt wins over Texas ST (-13') and So Alabama (-8). Last wk, ASU allowed just 293 yds and rallied to beat USA, 15-14, on a walk-off fg. Red Wolves 3-0 ATS at home with only SU loss to Iowa St by 8 pts. Georgia Southern also 3-4 so both are clawing for bowl eligibility. Eagles 0-3 on the road, though those were at Fresno, USC and JMU. In SBC play, they've lost to 2 of the top tms, JMU and USM, and are coming off 41-24 comeback win over rival Georgia ST. Both defenses are poor, but GS allows foes 100 ypg more than their avg (#133 FBS). This is a good spot for the ASU QB Jaylen Raynor (9-5 ratio) espec now that top WR Corey Rucker is healthy (27-283 last 3 gms). Back home and with 4 extra days of rest, ASU makes it 3 straight close wins.

Tennessee by 18 over KENTUCKY - Vols are 10-1 ATS in Lexington including 6 straight covers. LW's loss would have been much closer if not for QB Aguilar throwing a 98 yd Pick-6 on the final play of the 1H. Tenn finished w/4 410-373 yd edge but lost 37-20 (+9). Vols also were a missed fg away from upsetting Georgia and Led Ark by 17 4Q before 2 late td's made it closer. KY shut down a punchless Texas team LW but still lost 16-13 in OT. The 'Cats held Texas to 179 yards but the D will have a much tougher time against Tenn's tempo and explosive pass game. KY is 2-0 as home dogs this year and Stoops is 24-12-1 ATS vs ranked foes the L11Y but Heupel is 9-5 ATS off a SU loss and Tennessee absolutely owns this series. KY avg just 16 ppg/314 ypg vs SEC foes, not enough to keep up with Tennessee.

WYOMING by 3 over Colorado St - 117th mtg of the Border War. Colorado St has lost 4 straight in Laramie (0-4 ATS) and home team has covered 6 straight. Rams for to 2-5 SU & 3-4 ATS start. Last week's 31-19 loss to Hawaii (-174 yds) was final game for 4th yr HC Jay Norvell. CSU's wins are over Northern Colorado and Fresno St in a misleading final (-135 yds). Rams D allows 71 ypg above foes average (#120 FBS). Wyoming fell to 3-4 SU & 4-3 ATS with last week's 24-21 loss at Air Force. They held Falcons to ssn-lows in points and yards, and the defense is only giving up 23 ppg and is #18 in pass efficiency D. Cowboys have held last 3 opponents at least 54 yds below their average. Wyoming has the better squad, especially on the defensive side of the ball. But interim HC's are 5-0 ATS in their first game this yr when facing an FBS opponent. Wyoming wins but Tyson Summers, who has FBS HC experience, keeps CSU within a fg in this rivalry game.

4★ ATLANTA over Miami - MIA fell to 1-6 SU/3-4 ATS after a 31-6 beatdown at CLE, where they produced only 219 yds and turned it over 4 times, including 3 INT from Tua. The Dolphins have now dropped 7 of their last 9 ATS when scoring under 15 pts, and their defense continues to give up 29.3 ppg (#26). They enter here on a B2B road situation and are just 1-4 ATS in their last 5 away. ATL comes off a 20-10 loss at SF but still showed balance, with Penix throwing for 241 yds while the defense held the 49ers to 324 total yds. The Falcons rank #2 in total defense (265 ypg) and their front has consistently shut down opposing ground games, which should force MIA into obvious passing downs where mistakes pile up. With ATL owning nearly a 100 ypg edge on the season and boasting the superior defense, this is a matchup where their strength in the trenches and efficiency on both sides point to a decisive win.

3★ NEW ENGLAND over Cleveland - CLE rolled MIA 31-6 LW behind RB Quinshon Judkins' 3 TD runs, but despite the margin they finished with just 206 yds of offense and could've lined up in the wildcat all game vs a poor Dolphins defense and still cruised. QB Dillon Gabriel dinked and dumped his way to 116 yds passing, but that style won't hold up here against a disciplined NE defense. The Browns sit 2-5 SU/4-4 ATS and have gone 0-7 ATS in their last 7 road games vs a winning home team, and their offense continues to average only 16.1 ppg (#30). NE rolled TEN 31-13 LW as QB Drake Maye went 21-23 for 222 yds and 2 TD while RB Rhamondre Stevenson added 88 yds and a score, and the defense forced 2 TOs. The Patriots average nearly 10 more ppg than CLE and have hit the Over in 7 of their last 8 vs losing teams, with Maye providing a consistent passing edge that pairs well with a sturdy run game. With CLE's offense lacking punch and relying on dump-offs that won't work here, NE has the balance to cover easily and control throughout.

2★ Tampa Bay over NEW ORLEANS - TB fell to 5-2 SU/4-3 ATS after a 24-9 loss at DET where QB Baker Mayfield threw 50 times, but the Bucs are 6-0 ATS after a SU loss and still average nearly 25 ppg. With WR Mike Evans sidelined, WR Tez Johnson (4-58-1TD LW) stepped up alongside WR Emeka Egbuka and TE Cade Otton, giving Mayfield enough options to keep the pass game moving. NO slid to 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS after a 26-14 loss at CHI with QB Spencer Rattler tossing 3 INT despite WR Chris Olave's 98 yds and 2 TDs, and RB Alvin Kamara again bottled up as the Saints sit at just 17.9 ppg (#25). With TB owning the stronger QB play, a pass rush that can force Rattler into mistakes, and a 5-1 SU edge in this series the Bucs have the tools to control this matchup and win by a solid margin. **FORECAST: TAMPA BAY by 10**

OTHER PLAYS

Minnesota vs LA CHARGERS - TNF - MIN pushed PHI to the wire in a 28-22 loss despite outgaining them 402-371, as QB Carson Wentz threw for 313 yds but had 2 INT while WR Jordan Addison (128 yds) and WR Justin Jefferson (79 yds) kept the pass game rolling. The Vikings continue to deal with a strange QB situation, as rookie JJ McCarthy appears healthy enough but remains sidelined, leaving Wentz set for another start — and he's shown he can thrive under the TNF spotlight, going 7-0 in his career. LAC fell 38-24 to IND despite racking up 471 yds, with QB Justin Herbert firing for 420 yds and 3 TD while WR Oronde Gadsden II (164 yds, 1 TD) and WR Keenan Allen (119 yds, 1 TD) shredded the secondary. Both teams bring dangerous passing attacks, and with questions swirling at QB for MIN against LAC's high-volume aerial game, this primetime matchup shapes up as a back-and-forth battle where explosive plays could decide it late.

CINCINNATI by 14 over NY Jets - CIN moved to 3-4 SU/ATS after a 33-31 win over PIT, piling up 476 yds as QB Joe Flacco threw for 342 yds and 3 TD, RB Chase Brown ran for 108 yds, and WR Ja'Marr Chase exploded for 161 yds and a score. That offensive surge should carry forward at home, where CIN is 13-3 ATS vs losing teams and 8-2 ATS in its last 10 vs a losing road opponent. NYJ fell 13-6 to CAR with QB Justin Fields struggling before being pulled, and QB Tyrod Taylor came on in the 2H. Taylor has since been named the starter for this matchup, which may give the Jets a small spark, but their offense still managed only 220 total yds LW and continues to sit at 18.4 ppg (#31). With CIN riding momentum under Flacco and boasting a WR duo that's heating up, the Bengals are in strong position to extend NYJ's skid and win comfortably at home.

HOUSTON by 2 over San Francisco - SF moved to 5-2 SU/4-3 ATS with a 20-10 MNF win over ATL, riding RB Christian McCaffrey's 129 rush yds and 2 TDs while QB Mac Jones, who has now started multiple weeks with Brock Purdy sidelined, managed 152 yds and 1 INT. WR Deebo Samuel remains questionable, leaving this offense averaging just 20.7 ppg short-handed. HOU fell 27-19 at SEA on SNF, with QB C.J. Stroud throwing 49 times for 229 yds and a TD but again getting little help from the run game (31 rush yds), though TE Dalton Schultz (98 yds) and WR Jaylin Noel (77 yds) stood out. The Texans' defense ranks #4 in yds allowed (274 ypg) and gives up only 14.7 ppg, a clear strength that should test SF's injury-hit lineup. Both teams are off primetime games, and with SF short-handed while HOU leans on its defense, the Texans have the edge to sneak out a close home win.

Chicago by 3 over BALTIMORE - CHI improved to 4-2 SU/ATS after a 26-14 win over NO, powered by RB D'Andre Swift (124 yds, TD) and RB Kyle Monangai (81 yds, TD) as the ground game piled up 205 rush yds. QB Caleb Williams managed efficiently, and the Bears have now covered 4 straight while averaging 25.3 ppg (#12). BAL, at 1-5 SU/ATS, comes off a bye but remains in flux with QB Lamar Jackson questionable (hamstring). Even if he starts, his mobility may be limited, and this offense already sits at just 309 ypg (#22). The bigger issue is a defense surrendering 32.3 ppg (#30), consistently putting BAL behind. With CHI trending upward and BAL still searching for answers on both sides, the Bears are well-positioned to notch the road win regardless of Jackson's status.

Buffalo by 6 over CAROLINA - BUF comes off a bye at 4-2 SU but only 2-4 ATS, with QB Josh Allen a perfect 7-0 SU off a bye and never having lost 3 straight. The Bills average 27.8 ppg (#3) with 378 ypg, but their defense has slipped lately, allowing 22.8 ppg and >350 yds in consecutive outings. CAR improved to 4-3 SU/5-2 ATS after a 13-6 win over NYJ, though QB Bryce Young is out (ankle) and veteran QB Andy Dalton takes over. WR Xavier Legette (92 yds, TD LW) continues to emerge, and the Panthers' defense has been a steady top-10 unit (295 ypg, 21.7 ppg). CAR has covered 4 straight at home and matches up well enough defensively to keep this closer than expected. BUF has the firepower to win, but this shapes up as a spot where CAR hangs inside the number and grabs the cover.

PHILADELPHIA by 3 over NY Giants - PHI moved to 5-2 SU/4-3 ATS after a 28-22 win at MIN where QB Jalen Hurts (326 yds, 3 TD) carved up the defense with WR DeVonta Smith (183 yds, TD) and WR A.J. Brown (121 yds, 2 TD) both producing explosive plays. The Eagles remain strong offensively but have been inconsistent on defense, allowing 349 ypg (#21). NYG fell 33-32 at DEN despite 387 total yds, with QB Jaxson Dart throwing for 283 yds and 3 TD while WR Wan'Dale Robinson (95 yds) and TE Daniel Bellinger (88 yds, TD) provided big plays in the passing game. The Giants' defense still ranks near the bottom (376 ypg, #31), yet they've shown resilience 4-0 ATS in B2B road spots.

With PHI's passing attack giving them the edge but NYG's offense proving it can score and hang close, the Eagles are back for revenge but the Giants with Dart and Skattebo will keep it close.

INDIANAPOLIS by 17 over Tennessee - TEN dropped to 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS after a 31-13 loss to NE, where QB Cam Ward threw for 255 yds and a TD but the run game was bottled up (40 yds total) and the defense gave up 31 pts. The Titans are dead last in offense (236 ypg, 13.7 ppg) and have now failed to cover 7 straight after allowing 30+ pts, while also going 0-6 ATS in their last 6 when scoring under 15. IND improved to 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS with a 38-24 win at LAC, keyed by RB Jonathan Taylor (94 yds, 3 TD) and QB Daniel Jones (288 yds, 2 TD), as the offense racked up 406 yds. The Colts are averaging 33.1 ppg (#2) and have dominated this series (5-0 SU/ATS). Trends also favor points, with the Over 7-1 in IND's last 8 vs losing teams and 7-1 in their last 8 after holding an opponent under 90 rush yds, while TEN has hit the Over in 5 straight road games vs winning teams. With IND surging offensively and TEN incapable of keeping pace, this sets up as another lopsided Colts win with the Over in play. **Dallas by 4 over DENVER** - DAL enters off a dominant 44-22 win over WSH where QB Dak Prescott threw 3 TDs and RB Javonte Williams added 116 yds on the ground, as the Cowboys racked up 409 yds of offense. That attack now ranks #1 in the NFL at 390 ypg and 31.7 ppg, though the defense continues to sit dead last in total yds allowed. DEN, meanwhile, is coming off a 33-32 thriller over NYG behind QB Bo Nix, who accounted for 4 TDs and has added a spark to an offense averaging 347 ypg. The Broncos also bring in one of the league's stingiest defenses, allowing just 18.1 ppg (#3). This game should get loose, trends point heavily to points as DEN is 8-1 to the Over vs losing teams and DAL is 4-0 Over overall. Both sides have enough firepower to push this one past the number, but the edge leans slightly to DAL with their offensive balance.

Green Bay vs PITTSBURGH - SNF - This primetime matchup brings QB Aaron Rodgers back against his old Packers team, and he's been sharp this season with PIT despite the defense letting him down in a 33-31 shootout loss at CIN on TNF. Rodgers tossed 4 TDs in that game and will look to become just the 5th QB in history to defeat all 32 NFL teams, and the Steelers benefit from the extra rest heading into Sunday night. PIT also expects a spark with WR Calvin Austin trending back from injury, pairing with TE Pat Freiermuth and WR D.K. Metcalf to keep the passing attack dangerous. GB improved to 4-1 SU after a narrow 27-23 win at ARI, leaning on RB Josh Jacobs' 2 rushing TDs, but their offense has been inconsistent and the defense (#6 in yds allowed) has carried much of the load. WR Christian Watson's return should give QB Jordan Love another reliable target alongside WR Romeo Doubs, helping to balance the offense. With Rodgers facing his old franchise, both teams getting key WRs back, and each side trying to steady their defenses, this SNF matchup sets up with plenty of intrigue on both sides of the ball.

Washington vs KANSAS CITY - MNF - KC enters MNF fresh off a 31-0 shutout of LV where QB Patrick Mahomes threw 3 TDs and the defense suffocated the Raiders to just 95 total yds. The Chiefs' unit now ranks top 5 in both yds allowed (280 ypg) and scoring defense (17.7 ppg), and they're getting complementary play from RB Isiah Pacheco while WR Xavier Worthy continues to carve out a role alongside TE Travis Kelce. WSH dropped to 3-4 after a 44-22 loss at DAL, where rookie QB Jayden Daniels was banged up and gave way to QB Marcus Mariota in the 2H. Daniels is questionable with a hamstring, and if he can't go, Mariota would start — a shift that changes the Commanders' offensive style but still leaves weapons like WR Chris Moore and WR Jaylin Lane to push the ball downfield. WSH has been more competitive ATS following losses, and both sides should get a spark with extra WR help returning from injury. With KC's defense surging and WSH fighting to stay in the NFC mix, this MNF clash lines up as a test of whether the Commanders' offense can keep pace against Mahomes and a balanced Chiefs roster.
