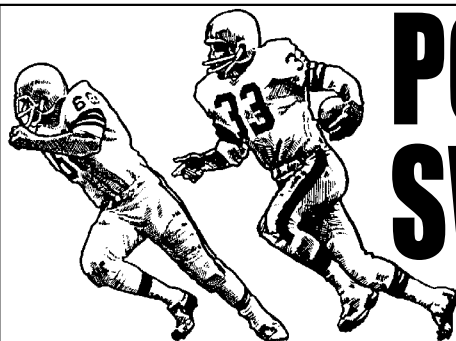

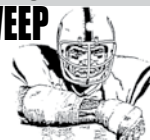

GAME OVERVIEW - SB 60 is in Santa Clara at Levi's Stadium with SEA vs NE in a rematch of Super Bowl XLIX. SEA got here with a 31-27 win over LAR in the NFC title gm, while NE beat DEN 10-7 in the AFC title gm. From an odds standpoint this is a true longshot matchup, with SEA entering the year at 60-1 and NE at 80-1, and it is the first SB since 2003 featuring 2 teams that missed the playoffs the prior season. Oddsmakers opened SEA as the favorite and the line is sitting at SEA -4.5 with a total of 45.5. The big SB angle to note is the dog's recent run, as underdogs are 15-7 ATS since 2004 and have covered five straight SBs, with dogs also thriving when catching 3+ points. Favorites also just went 6-0 SU in the Div + Conf rounds, and in the last five seasons that happened the SB favorite went 5-0 SU and 4-1 ATS.

RECORD VS THE SPREAD - NE is 14-6 ATS TY and 5-1 ATS their L6 gms. SEA is 14-5 ATS TY and has covered 4 straight. Both teams are over the 70% mark ATS, which is rare for a SB matchup. NE also comes off a non cover in the AFC title gm, winning 10-7 after closing -3.5, and SB teams off a Conf title gm non cover are 2-11-1 ATS since 1970. In general, SB favorites are just 27-30-2 ATS, so even with SEA laying points, this is setup with two top cover teams meeting without a clear ATS edge.

EDGE: NONE

TURF/SITE - SB 60 is in Santa Clara at Levi Stadium, and this is only the 2nd time the venue has hosted. The last time was 2016 in SB 50 when DEN beat CAR. It is an outdoor grass setup something both teams are used to. SEA has also been comfortable here lately, going 3-0 ATS their L3 gms at Levi Stadium. NE has only played here once since 2017 and they lost to SF 30-13. With SEA in the same div as SF, they have more reg reps with the trip and the building for a small bump.

SMALL EDGE: SEAHAWKS

SEAHAWKS #8 OFFENSE VS PATRIOTS #8 DEFENSE - SEA is avg 28.4 ppg and 351.4 ypg and Sam Darnold has been in full control. In 2 playoff gms he has 470 pass yds with 4 pass TD and 0 INT. Over his L5 gms he is 97 completions on 140 pass attempts (69.3%) for 1,085 pass yds with 7 TD and 3 INT. Kenneth Walker III has been the tone setter, avg 91.7 rush yds and 1.3 rush TDs his L3 gms, and JSN is avg 7.2 rec and 84.8 rec yds his L5. Cooper Kupp is avg 3.7 rec and 41.7 rec yds his L3 gms and has been there on key downs when SEA has needed it, and Rashid Shaheed adds another speed piece outside. SEA's pass pro has graded top 5, but NE's defense has been surging in the postseason with pressure and sacks piling up and a run D that has been hard to dent.

EDGE: SEAHAWKS

PATRIOTS #3 OFFENSE VS SEAHAWKS #6 DEFENSE - NE is avg 28.8 ppg and 379.4 ypg on the season, but they are avg 18.0 ppg in the playoffs with 16, 28, and 10 points scored. Drake Maye over his L5 gms is 76 completions on 116 pass attempts (65.5%) for 980 pass yds with 10 TD and 2 INT, but in the 3 playoff gms he has taken 15 sacks, 5 in each game. Rhamondre Stevenson is 17.0 rush att and 64.7 rush yds per game his L3 with 2.3 rec and 28.7 rec yds,

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and TreVeyon Henderson is 8.0 rush att and 19.0 rush yds per game his L3. Stefon Diggs is 3.7 rec and 24.3 rec yds per game his L3 with 1 TD, while Kayshon Boutte is 2.7 rec and 49.0 rec yds per game his L3 with 1 TD. SEA's D is allowing 17.2 ppg and 285.9 ypg and has been dominant late, holding opponents to 16.6 ppg their L5 gms, and that number drops to 6.3 ppg if you remove the 2 LAR games. This is also a front that can win with four and keep Maye under pressure all game.

EDGE: SEAHAWKS

SEAHAWKS#2 SPECIAL TEAMS VS PATRIOTS#14 SPECIAL TEAMS - SEA's return game can flip this fast with Rashid Shaheed. Since arriving in November, Shaheed has 13 punt returns for 210 yds for SEA, and he took the opening kickoff 95 yds for a TD in the DIV win vs SF. In the postseason he is avg 49.0 kick return yds, best in the playoffs, compared to NE returner Johnson at 26.5. On the kicking side, SEA K Jason Myers went 41-48 on FG (85.4%) with a long of 57 and perfect on XP. NE K Andy Borregales went 27-32 on FG (84.4%) with a long of 59 and 53-55 on XP (96.4%).

EDGE: SEAHAWKS

COACHING - This is a new era with both teams led by newer HCs and 1st time SB QB's, so there is not a long postseason history to lean on here. SEA HC Mike Macdonald is in yr 2 and NE HC Mike Vrabel is in yr 1. Both teams have been strong situationally all season and neither side has a clear coaching mismatch in this spot.

EDGE: NONE

PAST HISTORY MATCHUP/INTANGIBLES - These teams do not have much relevant recent history, as both are in a new era with new staffs and new QB's leading the way. The main "history" angle is simply that this is a rematch of SB 49, but the rosters and identities are completely different now. SEA does have some familiarity with the site from frequent trips to Levi Stadium, and both clubs have been elite ATS all season, so there is not a clean historical lean to hang this game on.

EDGE: NONE

CONCLUSION - SEA is playing its best football right now. Sam Darnold has 470 pass yds with 4 pass TD and 0 INT in 2 playoff gms. Kenneth Walker III is avg 91.7 rush yds and 1.3 rush TDs his L3 gms, and JSN is avg 7.2 rec and 84.8 rec yds his L5. NE has won with defense, but the offense has been a grind in the postseason with 16, 28 and 10 points scored, and Drake Maye has taken 15 sacks in 3 playoff gms. SEA's defense is the separator, allowing 17.2 ppg on the season and 6.3 ppg over their last 3 gms if you remove the 2 LAR matchups. Power Plays calls for SEA 22-18 and 40 total points, which is SEA by 4 and just under the number, so it is a no play on both the side and the total. We still like SEA here and see a more decisive performance than that projection, and unlike SB 49, this time SEA should be in control and not in a spot where one mistake at the goal line swings the game.
