4★ HOUSTON over Usf - This could be a prelude to the AAC Champ gm. The road team is 4-0 ATS in this series, but UH is 3-0 SU as AAC rivals. This is the lone home game in a 4 wk span for UH, while USF is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks. UH trailed Navy at HT, but scored 4 str TD's to begin the 2H as QB D'Eriq King threw for 413 yds. USF survived yet again LW, this time vs arguably the worst tm in FBS. After all'g a Uconn td to get within 1 score w/2:24 left, USF was able to recover the outside kick & run out the clock. UH is #6FBS on OFF avg 143 ypg more than their foes allow, while USF is #108 FBS on D, all'g 44 ypg more than their foes avg. USF HC Strong is 7-15 ATS vs foes off a SU win & we'll call for UH to hand the Bulls their 1st loss. **FORECAST: HOUSTON by 17**

3★ ARKANSAS over Vanderbilt - These two last met in 2011. Both teams are playing for a 9th straight week with a bye on deck. The Razorbacks got back in the win column last week by shutting out Tulsa 23-0 (-7). The Hogs held TU to a ssn low 260 yds. Connor Noland got his first career start with QB Storey inj'd (CS). Vandy enters off a 14-7 (+11) loss to Kentucky. Both teams are winless in SEC play but Ark is -108 ypg while Vandy is -186. Ark has also held 4 of their foes to their ssn low yards while Vandy allowed 2 foes to put up ssn highs. The 'Dores allow 266 (5.4) rush ypg in SEC play while Ark only allows 184 (4.6). This is Ark's 4th str home gm while Vandy is ply'g B2B on the road. The Hogs have covered 4 straight and we will call for them to make it 5 here. **FORECAST: ARKANSAS by 11**

3★ Texas over OKLAHOMA ST - It's homecoming in Stillwater, but the visitor in this series is on a 8-1 SU/7-1 ATS run. Both enter fresh off a bye. TX QB Sam Ehlinger (CS) was inj'd 2 wks ago & Shane Buechele (19 car sts) came off the bench to lead the 'Horns 6th str win. OSU has dropped 3 of their L/4 SU & ATS as they're all'g foes 78 ypg more than their avg in that span. The Pokes are all'g 194 (4.5) rush ypg in B12 play, while TX is avg 174 (4.4) rush ypg their L/2 gms. OSU is a HD for the 1st time in 3Y. TX is 7-3 ATS away from Austin. These teams are headed in opposite directions & we have no problem backing a much-improved Texas squad. **FORECAST: Texas by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ (Fri) BOSTON COLLEGE (+) over Miami, FI - It's the Red Bandanna game at BC (if you aren't familiar with the story, it's worth a read!). These former Big East rivals haven't met since 2012. Miami has won 16 of the L/18 mtgs but most of those mtgs came during the 'Canes heyday and BC has won 2 of the L/3. Both teams enter off fresh off a bye. Miami is switching back to QB Rosier who was benched earlier this ssn for QB Perry who threw 2 int's early in the 'Canes loss to UVA. BC RB Dillon has missed the last 2 games with inj and is still a ? here (ankle, CS). The 'Canes D has been tough to run against thanks to midsn AA Gerald Willis (36 tkl, 13 tfl) but earlier this year NC did run for 215 (5.4). QB Brown has compl'd 58% with a 14-4 ratio and faces our #13 pass eff D. The Eagles are 10-1 ATS vs ACC, 8-2 ATS at home incl 3-1 as a HD while Miami is 4-8 vs ACC foes. **FORECAST: BOSTON COLLEGE by 6**

2★ Florida (+) over GEORGIA - It's the World's Largest Cocktail Party. LY UGA ended a 3Y series losing streak by crushing Florida 42-7 (-13') with the Gators getting their only td in garbage time. Both teams are fresh off a bye with UGA suffering their first reg ssn loss since 2016 the wk prior vs LSU. HC Mullen has the Gators improving and they've won 5 straight (+93.8 ypg in those), covering each since their loss at KY. Georgia hasn't been nearly as dominant in the trenches which was most evident in their loss to LSU where they allowed 275 (5.4) rush. The Gators held that same LSU team to 180 (4.4) rush and finished +20 yds at home while UGA was -154 yds on the road. UGA is #21 on D, holding foes to 77 ypg below their avg while Florida is #42, holding foes to 52 ypg below their avg. The Gators have also put up the most yards 2 of their last 3 foes have allowed and QB Franks has a 15-5 ratio. We feel the improving Gators will stay within a field goal. **FORECAST: GEORGIA by 1**

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY October 25TH:

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 7 over Toledo - While UT is 6-2 SU (4-4 ATS), WM had won 2 in a row before losing 37-10 (+11) LY w/a bkp QB. Both tms are 0-2 ATS vs common foes but WM is 2-0 SU beating EM by 3 as a 4.5 pt HF & BG by 7 as a 14' pt AF, while UT is 1-1 beating BG by 16 as a 22 pt HF but losing to EM 28-26 as a 1' pt AF. WM is off a rout of rival CM 35-10 (-4). While their RB duo of Bellem & Bogan comb'd for 241 yds (6.3 ypc), QB Wassink rushed for a car high 3 td. UT led Buffalo 17-7 at HT but was held scoreless in the 2H with just 1 FD in the 4Q, losing 31-17 (-1). This is likely a MAC West elimination gm for UT. Still with UT allowing 4.8 ypc rush, we will look for the Broncos to continue their conf run (4-0 SU) with #28-58 Offensive edge.

OHIO by 10 over Ball St - Ohio won the last mtg 48-31 as a 9' pt HF in '15. TY both lost to NIU, Ball St by 8 as a 3 pt HD & Ohio by 3, but covered as a 4 pt AD as our Underdog POW winner, 2 wks ago. Against Kent St, Ball St won by 28 as a 7' pt HF, while Ohio only won by 1 as a 12 pt AF. The Bobcats got back on track LW blowing out a struggling BG 49-14 as a 16' pt HF. They had 2 players including QB Rourke, with 101+ rushing yds & 9.7+ ypc. Rourke also hit 8-14-193 with an outstanding 4-0 ratio. Ball St ran into a surging EM team, and trailed 35-14 at HT in a 49-17 loss as a 3 pt HD. While Ball St has a small defensive edge (#106-#115), Ohio has the edge on Off (#49-#73) and has made this their annual 'Blackout Game'. We look for the Bobcats to take care of business here to remain 1 gm behind surprising MAC East leader, Buffalo.

App St by 12 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - ASU has won 3 str over GS & leads this series 3-1 SU/ATS since both teams moved to the FBS in '14. Both are on short rest after ply'g just 5 days prior. This matchup will go a long way in determining who will reach the SBC title gm. LY ASU led just 13-6 in the 4Q, but got 2 TD's to pull away. ASU held the Eagles to just 111 rush yds (112 yds below ssn rush avg). Mountaineer QB Zac Thomas has been a standout in his 1st ssn (1,146 pass yds, 276 rush yds, 17 total TD) & more pressure is thrust on him after star RB Jalin Moore is OFY. GS has another strong rush attack, which is gaining 276 ypg, but will go up against a Mountaineer D that is holding foes to 115 ypg under their ssn avg & only allows 112 rush ypg. ASU is ranked for the 1st time ever as an FBS member, is 11-5 as away chalk & is on a 9-1 ATS run.

VIRGINIA TECH by 6 over Georgia Tech - VT has won all Thurs night meetings between these 2 and is 9-5 SU in the series but have lost the last 2. The dog is 12-1 ATS with 5 straight outright upsets in this series while the visitor is 8-6 SU/11-3 ATS. Both teams enter fresh off a bye. VT was outgained by NC 522-375 but pulled out a 22-19 (-6') win. QB Willis has topped 300 yds in 2 of his 3 starts and has compl'd 58% (8-3 ratio). GT is rushing for 352 (6.2) ypg but that drops to 232 ypg (4.0) when they face teams familiar with their option. Both OFF's rank in the top 45, while both D's have struggled. VT's D is #113, allowing 65 ypg more than their opponents' avg but they do have All-ACC DT Ricky Walker who is an NFL talent. HC Fuente is 8-4 as a HF and the Hokies did get extra time to prep for the option.

WEST VIRGINIA by 10 over Baylor - WV is 4-2 SU, but only 1-5 ATS in the series. Both enter fresh off bye. WV suffered their 1st loss 2 wks ago, being held to a ssn low 152 yds. QB Will Grier had Heisman hopes 3 wks ago, but has just a 5-4 ratio his L/2 gms. Expect a bounce-back effort as BU is #76 in our PDR & has all'd 15 td's with only 5 int's! The Bears have alternated W's & L's their L/6 gms and lost at TX 2 wks ago. None of the 3 FBS foes they have wins against has an above .500 record. WV is 4-12 ATS off a bye, while BU is 6-4-1 off a bye & HC Matt Rhule is 18-7 as a dog of 7+.

FRIDAY October 26TH:

Indiana by 3 over MINNESOTA - MN is on a 5-0 SU/ATS run when hosting IU, but this is just the 2nd mtg the L10Y. IU has lost 4 of 5 SU & is off a tough 3 gm stretch at OSU & vs Iowa & PSU, but does have a bye on deck. IU finished w/554-417 yd & 32-20 FD edges in their 5 pt loss to PSU LW. QB's Peyton Ramsey & Michael Penix split reps. MN has dropped 4 in a row SU. The Gophers trailed Neb 28-8 at HT & all'd the 'Huskies to pick up their 1st win while all'g 659 yds in the process. QB Zack Annexstad was hospitalized (CS) & Tanner Morgan took over & hit 11-16-214-0-1. This is MN's lone home gm in a 4 wk stretch. IU is off their best OFF performance of the ssn, while MN is off their worst D performance & is all'g 504 ypg, 224 (5.9) rush ypg & 72% completions in B10 play. **Utah by 13 over UCLA** - Following an 0-5 beginning to the year against one of the toughest sched-

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ules in the nation, the Bruins have now delivered 2 wins including a 1 pt victory LW at home against Arizona where QB Speight came off the bench to throw for 2 TD's (Thompson-Robinson inj'd). The Utes meanwhile have strung together their own winning streak over recent matchups (3-0 SU/ATS, 21 pt avg MOV) with their 13 pt victory vs USC in SLC (27-10 FD & 541-205 yd edges) the latest accomplishment (QB Huntley 22-29 for 341 yds & 4 TD). In LY's meeting in Utah, the Bruins (w/o QB Rosen) had no answer on the offensive side of the ball as they were outgained 506-249 in the 48-17 defeat. With the Bruins still being a tough team to gauge in the first year under Chip Kelly and the Utes on a 17-7-1 ATS run on the road dating back to '14, we'll go ahead and give the visitor the lean in this one.

COLORADO ST by 3 over Wyoming - This is the 110th mtg all-time of the Boarder War. While CSU leads the series 58-46-5, WY has won 6 of the past 9 gms SU, incl the last 2 yrs. LY these tms battled it out in the rain/snow and WY scored a TD w/ under 5 min left to take their first lead & won 16-13. Both have faced MW power Boise this ssn and neither tm had a good outing against the Broncos, as WY lost 34-14 at home (outgained 506-295) and CSU lost on the blue turf last week 56-28 (outgained Boise though 489-472). WY's offense is ranked near the bottom of the FBS and is avg'g just 289 ypg & 16 ypg, while CSU's offense is better when playing at home (474 ypg, 27 ppg). The Rams biggest offensive weapon is WR Preston Williams, who is among the top 10 WR's in the FBS w/ 825 rec yds & 8 TD's and he will be facing an okay WY secondary that is ranked 59th. CSU is 14-8 SU at home s/2016 while WY is 5-16 SU on the road in that same span. WY's defense is good enough to keep this gm close though.

Louisiana Tech by 3 over FAU - LY FAU won the first ever mtg by 23 pts, yet they were actually outgained 512-415. The Owls got a 98 yd KR td and LT settled for 4 short fg's (1 missed) in the 1H while FAU converted td's. FAU played their first game w/o CUSA Def POY LB Al-Shaair last week (ACL, OFY) and lost 31-7 (-3). The Owls put up their lowest yds since the opener (359) but actually held a +24 yd edge. QB Robison was intercepted 4 times and was benched in the 4Q with bkps Peavey and Johnson splitting reps. LT is off a closer than expected 31-24 (-23) win over UTEP. LT was actually outgained by 31 yds and UTEP had a chance to tie at the LT8 late 4Q. FAU avg 220 (4.9) rush ypg and their OL has allowed just 7 sks. LT's D is led by DE Jaylin Ferguson (9.5 sk) and they allow 146 (3.8) rush ypg. FAU's D is #105, allowing 38 ypg more than their foes avg and no longer have the heart and soul of their D. We will call for LT to pull the upset here.

SATURDAY October 27TH:

Middle Tennessee by 3 over ODU - MT has won both meetings by 31 pts at home LY and 13 pts on the road. QB Stockstill was nowhere near 100% last week with an inj'd ankle. He did throw 3 td passes and MT won despite putting up just 144 yds and had -215 yd and -10 FD deficits. ODU won in an absurd ending last week that involved 3 penalties that extended the final play, resulting in 2 missed fg's by WKU with the last one returned by ODU to set up a GW fg thanks to a penalty on WKU. The Monarchs put up the most yds that WKU allowed all ssn (508) and finished +44 yds. MT's struggles last week are understandable considering Stockstill was gimpy and MT faces a much weaker D this week with ODU #126, all'g 121 ypg more than their foes avg. It's hard to lean either way so we will take the points.

Nc State by 8 over SYRACUSE - NCSt is 6-1 SU/4-3 ATS in this series with the visitor 6-1 ATS. The Wolfpack was whooped 41-7 (+17) last week at Clemson. Cuse led 20-7 3Q then all'd 20 unanswered and HC Babers benched QB Dungey late 4Q. QB Devito rallied the Orange for a 40-37 (-10) OT win over NC. The Orange need one more win to reach their first bowl under Babers. NCSt is #10 on OFF, avg 112 ypg more than their foes allow. QB Finley is off his worst perf of the ssn with 156 pass yds and 2 int's. Cuse is only #94 on D, allowing 24 ypg more than their foes avg and while they do have 21 sks, don't expect much against a Wolfpack OL that has all'd just 3 all year. NCSt has shut down 2 running QB's this year and their D comes in #26, holding foes to 75 ypg below their avg. While Cuse is 8-2 as a dog, NCSt is 8-2 as an AF and we will take the Wolfpack off a loss.

VIRGINIA by 3 over North Carolina - Virginia snapped a 7 game losing streak to NC last year and is now just 2-6 ATS in the series. The visitor has covered 4 straight. NC is much better than their 1-5 record, evidenced by their +11 ypg mark on the season. HC Fedora's seat has gotten red hot after the Heels blew a 4Q lead for the 2nd straight week in their 40-37 (+10) OT loss at Cuse. UVA has pulled B2B outright upsets by beating Miami and Duke. The 'Hoos would love to become bowl elig in front of the home crowd where they've won & covered all 3 games this year. NC is +40 ypg in CUSA play while UVA is only +13. QB Elliott had his best perf of the ssn last week, throwing for 321 yds and 2 td's. NC has covered 7 of their L/8 as dogs and while we can't call for them to win, they should keep it close.

AKRON by 6 over Central Michigan - CM has won 7 straight vs Akron, including the last mtg 14-6 as a 3 pt AF in '15. Both tms lost to Buffalo TY, CM by 10 as a 7 pt HD and Akron by 18 as a 11 pt AD. They are both off playing their MAC rivals but while the Zips hung on to beat Kent ST 24-23 in OT (stopped 2 pt conv) as a 4 pt AF CM trailed WM 21-0 at HT and lost 35-10 as a 4 pt HD. That loss was CM's 7th, which ends their streak of 6 str yrs of bowl eligibility, which could make for a long rest of the ssn, for a team, who's only win was by 12 over and FCS foe. Akron stands at 3-3 including a win over Northwestern. While their hopes of repeating as MAC East champs is all but gone, they still have a shot at bowl eligibility. This looks to be a low scoring affair between to very similar tms as Akron has a slight Off edge (#121-#127) and CM has a slight Def edge (#83-#87). With that said we will side with the HT, that still has something to play for.

Duke by 7 over PITTSBURGH - Pitt is 4-1 SU (3-2 ATS) and LY got td runs of 79 and 92 from RB Darrin Hall in the Panthers' 24-17 (+8) win. Duke will have to try again to be bowl elig after losing at home to Virginia 28-14 (-7). They lost LT Jaylin Miller for the year and ply'd much of the game w/o LB Ben Humphreys (inj'd, CS). Pitt enters fresh off a bye and gave ND all the could handle the week prior. Pitt's OFF is #118, avg 72 ypg less than their foes allow. The main issue for the Panthers has been the lack of a pass game with QB Pickett only throwing for 146 ypg (62%, 6-5). Duke allows 144 (3.5) and has yet to allow more than 4.1 ypg despite facing 2 option teams. The Blue Devils D is #29, holding foes to 69 ypg less than their avg. We feel Duke will not allow Pitt to break the big runs this year and expect a better performance from QB Jones against Pitt's #77 pass eff D. Duke is 6-2 as an AF while Pitt is 8-15-1 ATS at home.

MARYLAND by 20 over Illinois - These B10 rivals have never met on the gridiron. IL is on the 2nd of B2B away games & is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks. They enter losers of 4 of 5 incl B2B by a comb'd score of 95-27. QB AJ Bush was just 2-8-10-0-2 LW at UW & MJ Rivers repl'd. MD has alternated W's & L's their L/6 gms & enters off a shutout loss at Iowa where they were held to a ssn low 115 tll yds in extremely windy conditions. RB's Ty Johnson & Anthony McFarland have comb'd for 864 (7.9) rush & IL is all'g 273 (6.1) rush ypg in B10 play. MD has ply'd our #20 toughest sked, while IL just our #62 toughest. IL is 8-19 as an AD.

LOUISVILLE by 3 over Wake Forest - Battle of 2 teams in the midst of disappointing ssn. WF picked up their first win in this series LY, 42-32 (+3). HC Petrino's seat is red hot after 4 straight losses prior to their bye. WF has lost B2B games incl LW to Florida St 38-17. The Deacons actually led 10-0 1Q but didn't score again until 4:36 left in 4Q. WF had just 1 available scholarship LB due to inj's and allowed FSU to put up a ssn high 485 yds. QB Hartman has completed 44% his L/2. Lville should put up their best pass numbers of the year while going up against our #120 rated pass eff D (worst among all P5's). WF is -192 ypg in ACC play while Lville is only -105. It's hard to put faith in either of these tms with both sitting at 1-6 ATS on the year so we will go with the home tm against a weaker injury ravaged defense.

Wisconsin by 3 over NORTHWESTERN - The home team is on a 7-3 ATS run in this series. The winner will stay alive in the B10 West Div. UW rebounded from their blowout loss at UM with a dominant win vs IL by over 4 td's that featured a snowstorm. RB Jonathan Taylor has ran for 100+ yds in every game to lead a rush attack that is avg 282 (6.3) ypg. NW enters on a 3 gm win streak, but was nearly caught looking ahead LW as they trailed RU in the 4Q & needed two 4th down conversions

on the go-ahead drive. NW may have found an answer for their run gm in true frosh Isaiah Bowser who had 108 (4.5). The 'Cats are all'g 163 (5.0) rush ypg in B10 play. The dog in NW games TY is 7-0 ATSI! NW is 3-1 as a home dog.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Army - LTH ('15) Army won 48-38 (-2). Army is 7-1 SU vs EM but 2-5 ATS. LY EM scored a td w/49 left, but the 2 pt conv failed & they lost 28-27 (+5). The Knights are off a very similar gm. After leading MAC foe Miami 21-7 late 4Q, Miami scored 2 td's in L4:23 to send the gm to OT but in 2OT Army stopped the 2 pt conv & won 31-30. The Knights were w/o st'g QB Hopkins (CS) but Cam Thomas, in his 1st car start led w/137 (5.3) rush. EM after 6 str gms decided by 7 pts or less (6 by 3 or less) exploded vs BSU, leading 21-6 at HT in a 42-20 (-3) win. They are led by former Iowa QB Wieggers, who had a ssn high 3 pass tds (22-28-258) & also rushed for a td. The bad news for EM is they're all'g 221 (5.2) rush ypg, while Army is avg 318 (4.8) rush ypg. The good news for EM is Army has a HUGE game on deck as if they beat AF (which already beat Navy), they would retain the CIC Trophy. That may mean Army resting some banged up players.

CHARLOTTE by 3 over Southern Miss - SM dominated Charlotte last year 66-21, putting up a ssn high 584 yds in the process. The Golden Eagles enter off a 27-17 (-16) win over UTSA, holding the RoadRunners to a ssn low 174 yds. HC Hopson said he wanted to put more focus on their struggling run game and true frosh RB Mosley went for 142 (5.5). SM finished +313 yds and +15 FD's. Charlotte held MT to a ssn low 144 yds but lost 21-13 in QB Shirreff's (Miami, FL transfer) first career start. The 49ers were +215 yds and +10 FD's. SM is #37 on D, holding foes to 55 ypg below their avg. UC is #10 on D, holding their foes to 116 ypg below their avg and they've held 4 of their 6 foes (incl L/3) to ssn low yards. SM has the edge on OFF, but Shirreff's could be an upgrade at QB in the long haul and RB LeMay has gone over 100 yds B2B gms. UC is 5-2 as a HD and we will call for the 49ers to pull the outright upset.

TCU by 20 over KANSAS - TCU is 6-0 SU as B12 rivals, but 1-5 ATS & has won their 3 mtgs in Lawrence by only 14, 4 & 1 point. TCU enters in an unfamiliar role having dropped 4 of 5 SU. Our Power Sweep star rated plays went a perfect 5-0 LW as we won our 4★ going against TCU in their 25 pt loss vs OU. The Frogs were held to a ssn low 275 yds & all'd a ssn high 536! QB Shawn Robinson hit 3-8-21-0-0 & was repl'd by Michael Collins. KU enters like they always do, seeking their 1st B12 win as they've lost 4 in a row by an avg score of 40-18. KU is avg just 308 ypg in B12 play & TCU is holding conf foes to 116 ypg below their avg. TCU is travelling for the 1st time in 5 wks & needs to gain confidence heading down the stretch. KU fired OC Doug Meacham unceremoniously 2 wks ago & he was TCU's OC from '14-'16 & still is close with HC Patterson. KU is 1-5 as a HD.

Massachusetts by 9 over CONNECTICUT - It's homecoming in Storrs. Just the 2nd all-time mtg as FBS foes. UConn won the only prior mtg here in the '12 opener 37-0 (-21). With neither sch'l ply'g for bowl elig, bragging rights are at stake for these New England rivals. This gm features the 2 worst defenses in the nation with UMass all'g foes 130 ypg more than their avg & UConn all'g a whopping 201 ypg more than their foes avg! The Huskies had been outscored by an avg 55-13 in FBS play before losing at USF by just over a td LW! UMass is travelling for the 1st time 4 wks, but is 0-5 ATS away. UConn is 25-16 as a HD, but 0-2 TY. UConn has ply'd the #44 toughest sked, while UMass has only ply'd the #113 toughest. Expect a shootout, but UMass QB Ford is a ? (CS).

Coastal Carolina by 6 over GEORGIA ST - 2nd mtg all-time. Last ssn was their 1st ever meeting & GST jumped out to a 21-7 HT lead, but had to recover an onside kick with under 2 min left to secure to a 27-21 win & the total yds were very close (GST outgained CC 366-364). These tms have faced 2 of the same foes in ULM and Troy. While GST & CC lost to Troy by 17+ pts, GST rolled ULM 46-14 (school record 308 rush yds), while CC gave up 466 total yds to ULM and lost 45-20 at home. GST comes into this gm with a few extra days rest (played last Thurs) while CC is off of a 24-13 road win at UMass (498-453 yd edge). GST does struggle defending the run (all'g 248 rush ypg) and struggles to rush the passer (just 7 sks in F/7 gms) and CC is a good running team, putting up 253 rush ypg this ssn. CC is just 1-3 as a home favorite, while GST is 8-3 as an away dog in SBC play s/2015. We think this game will come down to the wire.

UTAH ST by 23 over New Mexico - NM holds a slim 13-11 lead in this series overall, but Utah St has won 3 out of the 5 gms this decade. Last ssn NM actually outgained Utah St 340-243, but lost 4 fumbles and fell at home to the Aggies 24-10. These tms have played 2 common foes this ssn and each team won easily over both NMST (NM won 42-25, USU won 60-13) and UNLV (NM won 50-14, USU won 59-28). The Aggies offense has put up 439 yds & 48 ppg this ssn (WY held them to just 194 yds & 24 pts) and is led by QB Jordan Love (1,610 yds, 64%, 14.4 ratio), a 500+ yd RB in Darwin Thompson (535 yds, 7.3 ypc, 9 TD) as well as USC grad transfer WR Jalen Greene (22 rec, 312, 3 TD). NM's offense put up 500+ yds in B2B weeks earlier this ssn, but strugled the L/2 gms against CSU and Fresno, only scoring 7 pts & gaining 280 yds against the Bulldogs. USU is 5-1-1 as a DD MW favorite s/2015, while the Lobos are on a 2-7 ATS run against MW foes.

COLORADO by 24 over Oregon St - Following their first 2 defeats of the ssn the past 2 weeks on the road against USC and LW in Seattle against the Huskies where UW scored the final 13 pts in the 27-13 victory (CU just 15 FD's & 263 yds), the Buffs return to Boulder where they've outscored their 3 opponents by 20 ppg on the year. The Beavers meanwhile appeared to be sleepwalking following

their midssn bye as Cal handed them their 13th consec P12 defeat in a 49-7 blowout win (OSU outgained 539-241). In LY's matchup in Corvallis with interim HC Cory Hall making his debut for the Beavers, the Buffs won (-10) just a TD pass w/1:34 remaining to escape with a 3 pt victory (OSU 569-385 yd edge). With OSU on (-10) a 1-5-1 ATS mark as a conf AD and Colorado needing a victory here to get back in the running inside of the P12 South, we'll go ahead and lean with the HF who has cashed 3 in a row against the conf in that role.

Uab by 17 over UTEP - UAB is 4-1 SU/3-1-1 ATS in this series. The Blazers only led 14-7 LY but pulled out a 21 pt win. The Blazers continued their home dominance last week, beating North Texas 29-21 (-1) and we picked up a 4★ winner in our Totals GOM on the UNDER! UTEP once again played an upper echelon CUSA team closer than expected, only losing to LT 31-24 (+23). The Miners had the ball at the LT8 on their final poss despite being down to their 3rd string QB Brandon Jones, and also w/o RB Wadley. UAB is +116 ypg in CUSA play. RB Brown has rushed for 591 (4.4). UTEP is +13 ypg in CUSA play. Against 2 common foes (LT and NT), UTEP is -5 ppg and +10 ypg while UAB is +14.5 ppg and +49.5 ypg. We are impressed with what HC Dimel has done in a short period but the Miners are injury riddled and UAB's D is #24, holding foes to 82 ypg below their avg so we will call for the Blazers to win by more than 2 td's.

BYU by 9 over Northern Illinois - First meeting. BYU is 4-3 vs current MAC tms but has not played one since a 63-28 win over BG in 1983. Both tms are off a bye but NIU is making their longest trip of the ssn. The Huskies are 0-3 SU & 0-2-1 ATV in non-conf gms TY but are 4-0 SU (2-2 ATS) in conf play. BYU is just 2-2 SU & ATS at home TY. The Cougars need 2 more wins to become bowl eligible & with 3 of their final 4 on the road, including trips to play Boise St & Utah, look for them to put in a little extra effort here. NIU on the other hand after 6 straight MAC West titles from '10-'15 is looking to return to the MAC Championship game after a 2 yr absence. They have a short week ahead, as they travel to Akron on Thursday and so may be wanting to make the plane on time. We will take the more interested home team.

San Diego St by 8 over NEVADA - Will be the 7th straight year these 2 teams meet, with SDSSt holding a 5-1 SU (4-2 ATS) record against the Wolfpack. during that span. In fact, SDSSt has won the L/3 gms by an avg of 22 pts. Both teams have faced Air Force this ssn and each escaped with slim victories (SDSSt won by 4, NEV won by 3). Both teams have also faced Boise & both played the Broncos close, with NEV losing by 4 at home and SDSSt captured a 19-13 win on the blue turf. SDSSt has another masterful defense under HC Rocky Long as they are giving up just 18 ppg and are holding tms to just 84 total rush yds (held SJSSt to 62 rush yds). They are also holding foes to 84 yds below their ssn avg. NEV's offense has some big play potential (33 ppg, 432 ypg) and is off a big 40-22 win at Hawaii (481-371 yd edge). SDSSt is 10-4 as away chalk & we like the defensively sound Aztecs to pick up a road win.

STANFORD by 3 over Washington St - After an impressive home victory LW against the Ducks in Pullman where they led 27-0 at HT in the eventual 34-20 win (400-328 yd edge), the Cougars play host to a Cardinal team that ended their 2-game losing skid last Thur in Tempe against the Sun Devils (Stanford outgained 437-358, +3 TO's). In LY's meeting in Pullman, the Cougars had massive 26-9 FD & 430-176 yd edges, but still needed a TD w/6:56 remaining to escape with the 3 pt win and cover (-2). While we'll go ahead and call for Stanford to end their 2-game series losing skid this week on "The Farm", fading in their direction as far as the spread is a whole different story with the Cardinal covering just 5 of their L/14 as a HF and WSU HC Leach 15-5 as an AD.

USC by 7 over Arizona St - Despite a solid 437-358 yd edge last Thur at home against the Cardinal, the Sun Devils were forced into 3 TO's in the eventual 7 pt loss. They now head West to take on a Trojans squad that's come out victorious in each of the past 3 matchups (SU & ATS) with a 27 pt avg MOV. Despite jumping out to an early 14-0 lead LW in SLC against the Utes, the Trojans were held scoreless over the following 2 quarters with Utah gaining control in the process (41-28 victory, 541-205 yd edge). USC could be down to their 3rd string QB (CS). While USC has covered 3 straight contests heading in, a 7 pt lean is all that we can give here with the Sun Devils staying within a TD in each of their past 7 road contests.

Washington by 17 over CALIFORNIA - Following just their 4th P12 loss in the past 3 years the week prior in OT against the Ducks, the Huskies were able to hand Colorado their 2nd straight defeat behind a steady defense that surrendered just 15 FD's & 263 yds in the 14 pt win. UW is now back on the P12 road for the 3rd time in the past 4 weeks to take on a Cal team that ended their 14-gm P12 losing streak in easy fashion at Corvallis with a 49-7 victory (RB Laird 193 rush yds & 2 TD). In LY's meeting in Seattle, the Huskies held the Bears to just 93 yds of offense (fewest for OSU since collecting just 83 in 1991) in the 31 pt victory. While HC Wilcox would love to get an upset here against his former team (DC w/UW from '12-'13), it's hard to trust a Golden Bears squad that's covered just 2 games all season long.

Unlv by 6 over SAN JOSE ST - 6th straight mtg. SJSSt is 4-1 ST & ATS in that span, and if you go back to 1995 the Spartans are 7-1 SU in this series. The Rebels picked up their lone SU & ATS win last ssn. In the gm, UNLV jumped out to a 35-6 lead late 2Q and would go on to win 41-13 and outgained SJSSt 548-462 (SJSSt 3 TO's). Both teams enter off close MW losses as UNLV led 21-20 at HT, but gave up 21 3Q pts to Air Force and lost 41-35 at home (all'd 355 rush yds) while SJSSt threw a late INT to set up the GW GF for SDSSt and the Spartans lost 16-13 (all'd 207 rush yds). This could be the game for UNLV star RB Lexington Thomas (552 yds, 5.7 ypc, 6 TD) to get back on track against a DEF that is all'g 255.7 ypg the L/3 weeks. SJSSt is 1-17 their L/18 gms SU. This gm could see a lot of OFF as SJSSt is giving up 38 pts & 447 yds while UNLV is giving up 37 ppg & 466 yds.

A&M enters off a bye and are on a 3 game winning streak, all by a td or less. The Aggies allow just 78 (3.1) rushing. A few weeks ago, against a KY team that is also led by a run-first QB with a weak pass game, the Aggies didn't allow the 'Cats to cross the 50 yd line once and held RB Snell to 60 yds. MSU only allows 115 (3.2) rush ypg but A&M has the SEC's #2 rusher in Trayvon Williams (798, 5.7). The Aggies D has held their L/3 foes to their lowest yards this ssn while the Bulldogs have put up the least amount of yds that 3 of their foes have given up. A&M is 6-1 ATS this year and when MSU can't run the ball they can't win so we will call for A&M to win by double-digits. FORECAST: Texas A&M by 10

Tulane by 3 over TULSA - While Tulsa is on a 6-0 ATS run when hosting this series & has covered 3 of the L/4 overall, they were blown out by the Tulane option LY, all g ssn highs in pts (62) & rush yds (488, 7.0). Tulsa enters on a 6 gm losing streak & is again having trouble stopping the run as they're all g 251 (6.1) rush ypg in conf play. Despite the poor record they are just -24 ypg & RB's Shamari Brooks & Corey Taylor have comb'd for 1,031 (4.3). Tulane has dropped 4 of 5 SU & enters off an emotional home loss vs SMU. Up by 2 scores 4Q, they all'd 2 td's incl the GW 37 yd td pass w/1:15 left. Tulane is 14-60 SU away & 1-4 as an AD, but Tulsa is 7-11 as home chalk. Until Tulsa proves they can stop the run, we can't lean their way against the option.

Kentucky by 3 over MISSOURI - KY has won 3 straight in this series but MO is 4-2 ATS and covered LY in their 40-34 (+9) loss. We expected QB Lock to have a big game last week vs Memphis (always plays well vs non P-5 schools) and picked up a 3★ winner on these pages with MO in their 65-33 (-9). Lock threw for 350 yds and 4 td's. Lock now has a 64-9 ratio vs Non-P5/Non Bowl foes. KY is already bowl elig and QB Lock has a 21-28 ratio vs P5 bowl foes. The 'Cats are off a closer than expected win over Vandy. RB Snell went for 169 yds but the pass game struggled once again with QB Wilson throwing for just 18 yds on 9 pass attempts. KY's D is #11 holding foes to 108 ypg below their avg and are led by LB Josh Allen (#3 tk'lr, 8 sk). The 'Cats pass eff D is #14 and QB Lock's numbers have taken a drop under new OC Dooley (59%, 12-6). KY is 7-4 as an AD and we will call for the upset.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 7 over Tennessee - The last 6 mtgs in this series have been decided by 6 pts or less with 4 of them being outright upsets. SC has covered the L/3 and the home team is just 5-15-1 ATS. The Gamecocks enter fresh off a bye after their 26-23 (+2) loss vs A&M where they trailed 16-0 3Q and were out'd 458-299. The Vols are off their expected beatdown by Bama, and QB Guarantano was inj'd and is a ? (CS) but bkp QB Chryst did throw 2 H1 td passes. SC is -33 ypg in SEC play while Tenn was -102 prior to their loss to Bama. The 'Cocks are #30 on D, holding foes to 67 ypg below their avg. The Vols are #57 on D, allowing 21 ypg below their foes avg. HC Pruitt has the Vols much more competitive and the series history says this will be a close game so we will lean with the dog.

NORTH TEXAS by 30 over Rice - NT has won/covered the L/2 of this series. We picked up a 4★ Totals GOM winner going with UNDER 54 in NT vs UAB along with a 3★ winner going against NT on these pages last week. The Mean Green's CUSA Title hopes are all but gone now and they are already bowl elig. Rice ended a 2 gm td-less streak last week vs Rice and actually led 7-0 after 1Q and only trailed 16-10 3Q in their 36-17 loss at FIU (+23). The Owls were -206 yds and -3 TO's in QB Marshman's first career start. QB Fine (66%, 19-1 ratio) hasn't thrown for 300+ yds since their F/2 but he should have his way with Rice's #128 pass eff D. Rice is -128 ypg on the road while NT is +186 ypg at home and we will call for NT to take out their frustrations on their in-state rival with a win by over 4 td's.

Iowa by 3 over PENN ST - The series host is on a 6-2 ATS run. While not a true 'revenge' gm, Iowa certainly wants payback after Trace McSorley's GW 7 yd td pass w/ one time left LY in Iowa City. Iowa needs to win to remain in the hunt for a B10 West Title. This is strength vs strength as PSU is avg 484 ypg & is #15FBS avg 90 ypg more than their foes allow while Iowa is all g 258 ypg & is #6FBS holding foes to 128 ypg less than their avg! Both ply'd at Indy & PSU was -137 yds & Iowa was +149! In B10 action Iowa is +108 ypg & +14 ppg while PSU is +31 ypg & +10 ppg. The Iowa DL trio of Parker Hesse, Anthony Nelson, & AJ Epenesa continue to wreck havoc. Iowa is travelling for the 3rd time in 4 wks & is 22-10-1 ATS away from Iowa City & will hand the Nittany Lions their 3rd str home loss.

MICHIGAN ST by 3 over Purdue - PU is on a 4-0 ATS series run. MSU has lost 2 of 3 SU & enters off B2B physical gms vs PSU & UM. Their 14 pt loss LW was misleading as they were held to 11 FD's & 94 tti yds (-301 yds!). While RB LJ Scott returned, Sparty lost their top WR Felton Davis (Achilles & OFY) & QB Lewerke was repl'd after hitting 5-25-66. PU began the ssn 0-3 SU, losing by a comb'd 8 pts, & is on a 4-0 SU/5-0 ATS run & is brimming w/confidence following their surprising 29 pt blowout win over #2 ranked OSU! QB David Blough has thrown for 2,073 (67%, 13-2) to lead an OFF that is avg 514 ypg & is #11FBS avg 112 ypg more than their foes allow. MSU is all g just 80 (2.6) rush ypg, but is #62 in our PDR, all g 63% completions.

Fiu by 1 over WKU - WKU had their 4 game series win streak end LY in a 41-17 (-3) loss. The final score was misleading as 'Toppers actually led 17-13 3Q and finished with a +28 yd edge. FIU enters off a 36-17 (-23) win over Rice. The Panthers trailed 7-0 2Q and only led 16-10 at half but did finish with a +206 yd edge. QB Morgan now has a 16-4 ratio (65%). WKU has now lost 4 games by a fg after last week when they had 2 shots to kick a GW fg, only to have ODU return the the failed attempt into WKU territory, then get an untimed down after a WKU penalty for a GW fg. QB Shanley threw for 257 and 2 td's while the 'Toppers put up a ssn high 464 yds. FIU has all'd just 6 sks while WKU has all'd 19. WKU has covered their L/6 as a dog while FIU hasn't been an AF since 2016 so we will give a slight lean to the 'Toppers.

Cincinnati by 9 over SMU - This is SMU's 1st home gm in 4 wks, while UC is on the 2nd of B2B away gms. UC ply'd as a ranked tm for the 1st time s/12 LW, but suffered an emotional OT loss at Temple. Leading by a td 4Q, the 'Cats got 2 int's in the L/6 minutes, but then all'd a 75/7pl td drive w/49 left to send the gm into OT. SMU has won 3 of 4 SU & enters off an emotional win at Tulane. Trailing by 2 scores 4Q, the Ponies scored the GW td on a 67 yd td pass from Ben Hicks to James Proche w/1:15 left. SMU has struggled on OFF as they're #116FBS, avg 69 ypg less than their foes allow. QB Hicks was repl'd vs Navy & split reps w/William Brown before re-taking the job LW. UC is all g 278 ypg & is #14 FBS on D, holding foes to 104 ypg less than their avg. UC is 7-4 as away chalk, while SMU is 6-12 as a HD.

OKLAHOMA by 14 over Kansas St - It's homecoming in Norman. OU is on a 9-2 SU run, but the visitor in this series has covered 7 of the L/9. KSU is fresh off a bye & HC Bill Snyder is on a 11-1 ATS run in that role! KSU ply'd their best game of the ssn 2 wks ago, holding OSU to a ssn low 311 yds in their 19 pt win. After alternating QB's the F/5 wks, the L/2 gms have been stable as Skylar Thompson has taken every snap & RB Alex Barnes has ran for 431 (7.7!). Our Power Sweep star rated plays went a perfect 5-0 LW, led by OU's 25 pt win at TCU as our 4H (4H's now 7-1TY!). The Sooners finished +261 yds & held TCU to a ssn low 275 yds. Against 2 common foes (BU & TX) OU was +7 yds, while KSU was -211. KSU is 23-7 as an AD.

Arkansas St by 6 over LOUISIANA - This has been a close series as the teams have met every year s/2004 and LA holds a 8-6 SU edge (LA 9-4-1 edge ATS). The home team has also won the L/4 meetings both SU & ATS. Last ssn Ark St dominated the gm, leading 34-3 at HT (318-157 yd edge) and went on to win 47-3 as the Red Wolves outgained the Cajuns by over 300 yds (571-270). Ark St is off of dominating win last Thurs against Georgia St that saw QB Justice Hansen throw for 3 TD's and run for 2 more scores (333 tti yds) and Ark St picked up their 1st SBC win. LA is off a 27-17 loss at App St, where they held them to 113 yds be-

Ast is 8-4 as SBC away chalk. **TEXAS ST by 3 over New Mexico St** - These are former SBC foes & NMSt is on a 3-0 SU & ATS run against the Bobcats. Last ssn TXSt actually led 21-17 at the half, but then gave up 4 2H TD's to the Aggies and fell 45-35. Both teams have already faced Louisiana & Georgia StHrn and while they both lost to LA by 2+ TD's, TXSt almost upset GSthrn at home (lost 15-13, missed tying 2-pt att, held the Eagles to 159 yds below their ssn avg) while NMSt fell to the Eagles by 17 pts & all'd 389 rush yds. Despite their 1-6 record, TXSt is all g foes to gain 26 yds above their ssn avg, while NMSt is all g their foes to gain 126 yds above their ssn avg. TXSt has lost 7 straight FBS gms SU (3-4 ATS), but have an improved defense and are off a narrow 20-14 loss to ULM, while NMSt is off their loss to GSthrn and on a 5-12 ATS (7-10 SU) run, we expect this game to be close.

IOWA ST by 3 over Texas Tech - It's homecoming in Ames & ISU enters fresh off a bye. The 'Clones have won & covered each of the L/2 mtgs, winning by 37 ppg & covering by 42' ppg! ISU ply'd their best gm 2 wks ago in their 16 pt win vs WV. They're #5 FBS holding foes to 137 ypg less than their avg! RB David Montgomery ret'd from inj 2 wks ago & had a ssn high 189 (6.5) & the OFF has flourished under true frosh QB Brock Purdy (75%, 7-2 ratio). TT is travelling for the 2nd time in 3 wks, but enters having won 5 of 6 SU. True frosh QB Alan Bowman ret'd from a collapsed lung suffered just 3 wks prior & hit 36-46-408-3-1 LW. TT is avg 552 ypg & is #8 FBS avg 133 ypg more than their foes allow. Against 3 common foes (TCU/OSU/WV) ISU is +98 ypg & +6 ppg, while TT is +50 ypg & +6 ppg. TT is 11-4 as an AD.

Boise St by 12 over AIR FORCE - Teams have split the first 6 meetings (AF won 3 straight from 2014-16). AF has been incredible at home over the last 5 ssn's, going 22-5 SU and won 2 straight over BSU. BSU did win LY, leading 27-10 HT (255-155 yd edge) and won 44-19 and held the Falcons to 181 rush yds (125 under their ssn avg). BSU is off of a 56-28 win vs CSU, where QB Rypien got back on track (22/26 for 308 yds & 4 TD's) but BSU was outgained (489-472) & out FD'd (27-26), but did force CSU into 3 TO's. Despite AF's QB Donald Hammond being out with inj, they still won 41-35 at UNLV and bkp QB Isaiah Sanders started & accounted for 390 tti yds (4 TD's) in the win. Hammond's status is still up in the air for this one, but Sanders looks more than capable of handling the QB job. BSU is 38-17 as road chalk. Both enter off a win, but we like the more talented Broncos squad to take this one.

Clemson by 13 over FLORIDA ST - Clemson has won 3 straight in this series and while they did cover last year by winning 31-14 (-16), the final was misleading as the Tigers only led 17-14 4Q and added 2 td's in L/3:05. Clemson dominated NCS last week, winning 41-7 (-17) with QB Lawrence throwing for 308. Clemson finished with a 174 yd edge but did get held 7-1 (2.8) rush yds. FSU was off a bye and crushed WF 38-17 (-9), though they did trail 10-0 1Q. The 'Noles D allows 62 ypg less than their foes allow (#34 in FBS). Clemson has the #1 DL in the nation which has 21 sks on the ssn. FSU's OL has been an issue all year long (18 sks all'd), but did have their best perf of the year after their bye with 0 sks allowed and a ssn high 134 rush yds. FSU is in a rare spot as a HD (0-4 in L10Y). FSU did play Miami much closer than expected a few weeks ago so we will lean with the Noles as a 2 td dog here.

† **Notre Dame by 21 over Navy** - TY's annual rivalry gm is being played in San Diego, where there's a large Naval presence, at the former home of the NFL's Chargers. This is the 7th different venue in the L11Y. Navy is on a 4-1 ATS series run & the last time they ply'd on a neutral site (16 in JAX) Navy won outright! ND enters fresh off a bye & the last time they were undefeated this late in the ssn & ply'g Navy was 1993! Navy has dropped 4 in a row SU & by going for 2 on each of their L/2 td's vs UH LW cost their backers & our 'Undedog POW' on these pages a cover. QB Malcolm Perry inj'd his leg & missed most of the 2H (CS). Navy is 29-16-1 as a dog.

Oregon by 16 over ARIZONA - Following a narrow 1 pt loss LW in Pasadena against the Bruins without the services of QB Tate (Rodriguez 15-34-231-2-2), the Wildcats return home to take on a Ducks squad that's won 7 of the past 9 meetings in the series including a 20 pt win LY in Eugene (588-330 yd edge). Oregon meanwhile is on the road for a 2nd consec weekend following a trip to Pullman that saw them trailing 27-0 at HT in the eventual 14 pt defeat. With Oregon still covering 4 of their past 6 inside of the P12 and the Wildcats being outgained by a 445-387 yd clip at home so far this year, we'll be backing the visitor in a series that they've clearly owned over the last decade.

FRESNO ST by 17 over Hawaii - Fresno has dominated this series, going 7-2 SU (5-3-1 ATS) s/2009. Hawaii started the ssn 6-1 (467 ypg, 38 ppg), but have lost the past 2 gms and their offense has struggled (341 ypg, 22.5 ppg). It will get even tougher for UH vs Fresno as the Bulldogs defense is all g 298 ypg & 13 ppg this ssn and are holding their foes to 95 yds below their ssn avg. In fact, the L/3 weeks Fresno is all g 276 ypg & 13.2 total pts (4.3 ppg). Fresno's OL has also done a great job of protecting QB McMayrion (71% comb rate, 14-2 ratio) as he has only been sacked 5 times all ssn. Both teams already beat Wyoming this ssn (Fresno won 27-3, UH won 17-13) and while Fresno won 21-3 over Nevada, UH is off of a 40-22 loss to the Wolfpack, where they all'd 481 yds. Fresno HC Tedford is 16-3-2 ATS s/ taking the HC job here and is 8-1 SU (7-2 ATS) at home and has won those 8 homes gms by 31.3 pts. UH struggled against an avg defense last week and we think those struggles will continue & will call for Fresno to win this game by multiple scores.

TESDAY October 30TH:

Kent St at BOWLING GREEN - BG has outscored KS 205-65 over the last 5 mtgs incl a 44-16 win LY as a 2 pt AF. The Falcons fired HC Jinks the Sunday following their loss to WM. That gave DC Carl Pelini, the new interim-HC just 5 days to prep for Ohio. He will have a few extra days to prep for this game, and so this will be a truer audition for the HC job. The Flashes are under 1st yr HC Lewis, who is still looking for his first MAC win. Both are 0-4 in conf play, but while BG's closest conf loss is by 7 pt, KS has lost 2 by 1 pt including a 27-26 loss to Ohio, which beat BG 49-14. This is the battle to stay out of the MAC East basement.

Miami at BUFFALO - The Bulls had won 4 straight before losing the last 2. LY Miami started their backup QB but Buffalo was down to their 3rd string QB, as they started a true frosh QB for the first time since '05. Miami finished with a 349-271 yd edge in a 24-14 win as a 2 pt HF. TY both starters should play. This is a showdown for the lead in the MAC East as UB is 4-0 & MU is 3-1 with the winner holding the first tie breaker.

4★ CAROLINA over Baltimore - While the Panthers were unable to climb back from a 17 pt HT deficit a week earlier against WAS, they accomplished that feat a week ago in PHI with 3 unanswered TD's in the 4Q to claim the 4 pt win (371-342 yd edge). BAL on the other hand fell short in shocking fashion with one of the greatest K's in NFL history missing the game-tying PAT at home against the Saints. In their most recent meeting back in '14, BAL had no issue disposing of the Panthers in the easy 38-10 win (QB Flacco 327 pass yds & 3 TD). With BAL failing to cover 8 of their past 10 against NFC foes and CAR getting some home cooking after a pair of road trips, we'll back the Panthers here as they've covered 9 of their past 13 against the AFC. **FORECAST: CAROLINA by 7**

3★ KANSAS CITY over Denver - The Broncos and Chiefs square off for the 2nd time this month with KC capturing the 27-23 win (-3) inside of "Mile High" on MNF in the earlier matchup (DEN QB Keenum overthrew a wide-open WR Thomas w/16 left in what would have been the game-winning TD). While DEN did head into the desert last Thur with just a 1-9 SU/ATS mark on the road under HC Joseph (incl 8 DD losses), they capitalized on some early mistakes by the ARZ offense (2 pick 6's) in the 45-10 blowout win. KC meanwhile earned a 35 pt win over CIN in Arrowhead (QB Mahomes 4 more TD passes) while keeping their spread streak intact at 11-0 ATS. With DEN on just a 3-12-1 ATS run against DIV foes heading in and KC posting a dominant 12-2 ATS mark in the same role, it's no surprise that we're leaning with the home tm in this one. **FORECAST: KANSAS CITY by 16**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ San Francisco over ARIZONA - While the 49ers closed out the '17 campaign with 5 consec wins and covers, the current year has seen a different story as they're currently sitting at just 1-5 SU & ATS following LW's 29 pt home loss to the Rams where they coughed up the ball on 4 more occasions (league-worst -15 TO ratio TY). ARZ is back at home with extra rest after a Thur night matchup against DEN where they were forced into 5 TO's (incl 2 pick 6's) in a 45-10 defeat (DEN 309-223 yd edge). In their earlier '18 meeting in the Bay Area, the 49ers had massive 33-10 FD & 447-220 yd edges but were done in by 5 TO's in the 10 pt defeat. With SF seeking revenge from the prior contest and having covered 10 of their past 16 matchups against the NFC West, we'll go ahead and give them a 3 pt advantage here and reduce their TO's against a Cardinals team that made a change at OC following the DEN loss with former NFL QB Byron Leftwich (current QB cch) taking over for Mike McCoy (ARZ avg just 12 ppg and 223 ypg at home TY). **FORECAST: SAN FRANCISCO by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

Miami at HOUSTON - Thursday - Following a split 2-game homestand where they got past CHI in OT and fell to the Lions by a 32-21 score a week ago (DET 457-322 yd edge), the Dolphins head to Houston to take on a Texans squad that took advantage of a struggling Jaguars squad LW in JAX (3★ Newsletter Winner on Texans). In their most recent meeting back in '15, the Texans trailed 41-0 at HT in the eventual 18 pt defeat. With both teams in play against mode as far as trends are concerned (MIA 3-8 ATS as an AD, HOU on a 2-10 overall ATS run), **check back on gameday at Noon EST to get one of our very special Marquee selections.**

† Jacksonville by 3 over Philadelphia - London. Had it not been for a 10 pt blown 4Q lead in LY's AFC Championship against NE, the Jags would have met the Eagles in SB 52. Following another struggle LW vs HOU where they dropped their 3rd consec gm (held scoreless in the 1H in each) and benched QB Bortles in the process (bhp Kessler 21-30-156, 1-1 ratio), the Jaguars head across the pond to their home away from home inside of Wembley Stadium where they've had some tremendous success over the past 3 yrs with outright upsets in each including a 44-7 win (+3) LY against the Ravens. PHI meanwhile blew a 17-0 lead in the 4Q LW at home against the Panthers (CAR 371-342 yd edge) for their 4th loss of '18. While PHI has had some non-conf success from '14-'17 with a 12-3-1 ATS mark, the '18 campaign has seen them drop a pair of covers against the Colts and Titans. Despite also having a porous non-conf spread mark at just 4-19 for the Jaguars along with a handful of hiccups over the past few weeks, we expect JAX to get the job done against the defending champs who are making their first trip to England.

PITTSBURGH by 6 over Cleveland - Rematch of an exciting '18 opener that finished as a dud with a 21-21 tie in wet and rainy conditions (PIT 472-327 yd edge, -5 TO's). The Browns head to the road for a 2nd straight week after what appeared to be yet another tie LW in Tampa (4th OT game of the ssn) before the Bucs connected on the GW 59-yd FG w/1:50 remaining in the extra frame. The Steelers meanwhile return from their bye with added confidence following a huge win the week prior on the road against the Bengals. While CLE is on just a 6-14 ATS run vs DIV foes, they are a perfect 2-0 ATS so far TY. With a trip to BAL on deck to take on a Ravens squad that manhandled them a few weeks back, PIT (1-5 ATS as DIV HF & 1-6 ATS after a bye) could lose interest late allowing CLE to stay within range of the cover.

CHICAGO by 8 over NY Jets - Following a completed Hail Mary at the end of regulation that fell just short of the goaline in the 7 pt loss to the Patriots (CHI 453-381 yd edge), the Bears welcome a Jets squad that was unable to get the job done at home for a 3rd consec week (beat DEN & IND) against the Vikings. The Jets are on a 7-19-2 ATS run as a NDIV AD that ironically dates back to their last Soldier Field visit against CHI where they dropped a 4 pt contest (+3). In their most recent meeting at home against CHI on MNF, the Bears earned an 8 pt road win (+2) in a game that the Jets had a 414-257 yd advantage. While the Jets have done much better than we expected entering the midway point of the ssn, a solid CHI offense that's #6 in the NFL at 28.3 ppg should get the job done in this one.

Washington by 4 over NY GIANTS - The Redskins held off a late charge by the Cowboys at home to move into the lead atop the NFC East standings (3.5★ LP Top Play LP Winner on UNDER 41.5, **Weekly NFL Top Play Late Phone Plays are now a perfect 7-0 on the year, don't forget to check out our October Game of the Month this Sunday!**). The Giants meanwhile entered their MNF matchup against the Falcons with a 1-5 mark for a 2nd consec year. In LY's ssn finale matchup at MetLife Stadium, the Giants earned the 18-10 victory (+4) with a solid 381-197 yd edge. With this series seeing a split in each of the past 3 years including a 2-0 mark by the visitor in '16, it's not too hard to fathom a solid victory by the Redskins in this one.

DETROIT by 4 over Seattle - Only HG in a 4-wk span for DET as they have key DIV trips to MIN and CHI on deck. LW they jumped out to a 10 pt HT lead in MIA and never looked back in the 32-21 victory (457-322 yd edge). SEA returns from their bye wk with heavy hearts following the death of owner Paul Allen the day after their London matchup against OAK. These 2 last met on MNF in the early part of the '15 ssn with the Lions nearly stealing away the upset victory (13-10 loss) as a 9 pt dog (DET fumbled into EZ for a TB w/1:45 remaining). With DET on a 14-6 ATS run as a HF and SEA posting a 9-18-3 ATS mark as a NDIV AD, we'll go ahead and give the home team the small edge in this one.

CINCINNATI by 9 over Tampa Bay - While the Bucs' change at DC prior to their matchup with the Browns appeared to work early on with a 15-2 HT lead, some of their prior troubles showed up late with CLE eventually forcing OT (TB GW 59-yd FG w/1:50 left in the extra frame). They now head North to take on an angry Bengals squad that's dropped 2 in a row following their 35 pt blowout loss in Arrowhead to the Chiefs (KC 33-15 FD & 551-239 yd edges). In their most recent matchup back in '14, the Bengals came away with a 1 pt win road win in a game that featured a total of just 27 pts & 551 yds. Although it's fair to expect a heavier dose of offense this time around, we also expect the Bengals to get back on track as well and cover here as they're on a 7-3 ATS run prior to their bye.

Indianapolis by 3 over OAKLAND - OAK returns to action following a week off (5-1 ATS off a bye) sitting at just 1-5 to start the Gruden era including an embarrassing effort in their most recent matchup in London against the Seahawks. Their lone win of '18 did come in the "Black Hole" in controversial fashion against the Browns in the final week of Sept. While the Colts did handle the banged-up Bills LW at home by a 37-5 score (4 TD passes from Luck), they are on the road for the 3rd time in a 4-wk span (lost to NE & NYJ by a combined 22 pts). With the Colts on a perfect 5-0 ATS run prior to their bye week and OAK posting a 2-7-2 ATS run overall, favoring the Silver & Black is unwise at the moment.

LA RAMS by 6 over Green Bay - Only home matchup in a 5-wk span for the Rams who return to LA following a trio of road victories against the Seahawks, Broncos and LW in SF where they held the 49ers to just 10 pts & 228 yds. While the Packers had covered 9 straight following a bye from '06-'14, the past 3 years have seen them go 0-2-1 ATS including a pair of outright defeats. In their most recent matchup in Lambeau, a then St Louis Rams squad was shutout in the 2H in GB's 24-10 victory (-9). While the Rams finally covered a lofty spread a week ago (thanks in part to +4 TO's), their home venue will likely be taken over by "Cheesehead Nation" here giving Aaron Rodgers and company some added fuel to keep this contest close.

New Orleans at MINNESOTA - SNF - It's been just over 9 months since the "Minneapolis Miracle" and the Saints faithful are still stinging from having certain victory and a trip to the NFC Championship ripped from their hands following a 61 yd TD pass as time expired. While the Saints fanbase is still struggling to get over it, the team is on quite the roll following their 5th consec win LW in BAL where the Ravens missed the game-tying PAT w/24 left (Brees 4th QB in NFL history w/500 career TD passes). The Vikings meanwhile are sitting alone atop the NFC North standings (by just a half game) following a 20 pt win on the road against the Jets where WR Thielen again finished with 100+ yds (100+ in all 7 games TY). While MIN is on a 16-4-1 ATS run as a HF, the revenge factor for the visitor has us passing on making a prediction on this game as of presstime. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

New England at BUFFALO - MNF - Following a close victory LW in Soldier Field against the Bears where NE tackled a CHI WR at the 1-yd line on the final play following a Hail Mary (7 pt win, CHI 453-381 yd edge), the Patriots head to Buffalo where they've come out with 6 consec SU victories (5-1 ATS) with a 14 pt avg MOV. The Bills meanwhile are fresh off a part of their '18 schedule that saw them make 4 road trips over a 5-week span. With Derek Anderson (20-31 for 175 yds & 3 int) under center LW for the inj'd Allen in IND, the Bills were held to just 5 pts in the 32 pt defeat. While this contest appears to be a mismatch on paper with BUF posting just a 4-8 ATS vs the AFC East and NE 9-4 ATS inside of their DIV, keep in mind that the Patriots need to cover a fairly elevated line along with preparing for a big matchup with the Packers in Foxboro.
