Utah made it here LY but lost to Washington in a defensive struggle 10-3 (+5). Oregon is playing in their 3rd P12 Title game and first s/14. PP is calling for Utah to win its first P12 Championship by nearly 2 TD's and we agree. The Utes have covered 3 in a row in the series. Utah has held all 12 of their opponents under their ssn average in total yds and PP is forecasting Oregon to be held to a ssn low 262 yards, which is 190 yards less than the Ducks average! The Utes are on a 8-0 overall ATS run, while Oregon is 3-12 ATS as an underdog. If given the chance, Utah will likely pour on for style points with a berth in the College Football Playoff still possible.

The last meeting between these two was in 2017 and MU has covered the L/3 meetings. PP is calling for Central Michigan to win its first MAC Championship since 2009 and we agree! Miami was held under 270 yards in each of their first four FBS games this year, but did average 347 ypg in conference action. CM is +168 ypg vs MAC foes while MU is only -6. PP is forecasting the Chippewas defense, which held Toledo to a season low 256 yards last week, to allow the Redhawks just 277 yards. Miami was held to only 275 yards at Ball St last week and took several injuries which PP doesn't even take into account. Central Michigan has too much offensive firepower for Miami to keep this game close.

This is a rematch from last year's Sun Belt Championship game and PP is calling for Appalachian St to make a successful defense of their Title. We agree and also feel that the Mountaineers will win, but while PP has this game finishing as an 8 point margin, we disagree and feel that Louisiana will keep this game closer than expected. The host in this series is just 1-6 ATS and the Cajuns are 3-0-1 ATS as an SBC road dog under HC Napier. While Appalachian St did beat Louisiana by double-digits earlier this season, the Cajuns have won six straight since, with their smallest MOV prior to last week being by 10 points.

Despite PP projecting Oklahoma to finish with a commanding 481-320 yard edge, it cannot decide a winner as the final result is ending in a tie! We disagree and feel like the second half of the initial meeting three weeks ago will be the more likely outcome. After trailing by 3 td's at halftime, the Sooners held Baylor to 57 yards in the second half and got a come from behind victory. After finishing with just 307 yards in the initial meeting, PP is calling for the Bears to finish with 320 yards this week while Oklahoma will have it's high octane offense that is averaging 146 ypg more than their opponents allow even stronger due to WR CeeDee Lamb being available (didn't play due to injury in initial meeting).

First meeting between these programs since 2013 and first meeting between 2 of CUSA's top coaches, Bill Clark and Lane Kiffin. Both teams are 1-0 in CUSA Title games, with UAB winning last year at Middle Tenn 27-25 (+1) and FAU beating N Texas the year prior 41-17 (-11). FAU is +45 ypg and +95 ypg in CUSA play. UAB is +94 ypg and +103 in CUSA play. Dylan Hopkins has started the L/4 for the Blazers due to QB Johnston's inj (CS). Hopkins is only completing 51% w/a 3-4 ratio. The Owls have the edge on offense and Special Teams while UAB has a big edge on defense. The Blazers have held all but 2 opponents under their season avg. PP projects FAU to win by nearly 2 td's which isn't surprising considering all 9 of the Owls wins have come by DD's but the yards are only 386-325. We agree with the yards projection and while we don't think UAB wins, we think they keep it closer so we'll pass.

These two just met last week in the same location with Memphis pulling out a 34-24 (-12) win. After being held under 100 pass yards in B2B games, Cincy QB Ridder was held out (Shoulder) and backup QB Bryant threw for 229 with a 1-2 ratio. Memphis has won 4 in a row

in the series but Cincy has covered 8 of the last 10 and the visitor is on a 5-0 ATS run. This is the Tigers 3rd straight AAC Title game. Cincy is making their first appearance. The Tigers are +83 ypg in AAC play while Cincy is -40 and they've been outgained in 7 of their last 8 games. PP calls for Memphis to win by 2 td's with a more emphatic yardage edge than last week, 476-323. The Tigers are on a 20-7 ATS run. We agree with the projection and will call for the Tigers to win and get their New Years Day Bowl Bid.

Hawaii makes their 2nd trip to Boise this year, the Broncos won the first meeting 59-37 (-13) and we picked up a 3★ LPS winner in that game. The Broncos have won 5 straight despite QB Bachmeier's inj (missed L/4, Check status). Hawaii started the ssn 4-1 then lost 3 of 4 before rattling off 4 straight wins. UH is 2-3 SU/1-3-1 ATS vs bowl eligible foes. Boise St is 6-1 SU/4-3 ATS vs bowl eligible foes. The Broncos hold huge edges on Def and ST's. PP calls for Boise St to win by 18 pts, though the yds suggest a closer game. We don't mind the yds projection considering the last meeting was nearly identical with Boise St holding a 518-438 yard edge and the Broncos will look to get some style points in their quest to get a New Years Day 6 Bowl game.

LSU is playing in their 6th SEC Title game (4-1 SU/2-1-1 ATS) while UGA is playing in their 3rd consecutive, and 8th overall (3-4 SU/5-2 ATS). These two have played in the SEC Title game on 3 occasions, with LSU winning in '11 and '03 while UGA won in '03. LSU enters 12-0 SU/8-4 ATS on the season. The Tigers have put up the most yards that 7 of their foes have allowed. UGA is on a 6 game winning streak and they've held 4 of their foes to their season low yards. PP projects LSU to win but calls for UGA to keep it within the opening Vegas line. The yds also suggest a close game. We disagree and can't trust a Dawgs offense that has been held under 275 yds in 3 of their L/6 and QB Fromm has struggled (47% over L/4).

OSU is making their 5th trip to the Big 10 Title game (3-1 SU/ATS) while Wisconsin is appearing for a conference high 6th time (2-3 SU/1-4 ATS). This is a rematch of earlier season meeting when Ohio St won 38-7 (-14). The game was played in heavy rain and the Buckeyes finished with 431-191 yard edge and they held Jonathan Taylor to 20-52 (2.6). PP calls for a closer game this time around with OSU winning by just under 3 touchdowns with a 496-328 yard edge, but the line is only 16' so the lean is still with the Buckeyes. We see no reason to go against Ohio St, who is on a 10-1 SU/9-2 ATS series run and an 11-4 over ATS run while Wisconsin is on a 6-12 ATS run vs Big 10 foes.

First meeting since 2013. Clemson looks to win their 5th consec ACC Title and they are playing in their 6th ACC Title game. UVA enters off an emotional win over VT and is playing in their first ACC Title game. The Tigers are 18-8-1 ATS during their 27 game win streak. 'Hoos enter on 4 game win streak (3-1 ATS). Clemson has covered 6 straight vs FBS foes, winning by 42 ppg. PP calls for the Tigers to hold UVA to a ssn low 236 yds while also putting up 540 yds, which would be the most UVA has given up in '19. The projected margin of victory is leaning with the underdog, so despite CU's 16-2-1 ATS run vs ACC foes, we'll have to pass.
