THE MOST UNIQUE POWER RATINGS IN THE COUNTRY

These Power Play Forecasts are the most unique in the country because they are based on **Northcoast Sports' Private Power Ratings**. Our ratings are unlike any computer rating, as we take into account all of the following: Strength of Opponents Individual Units (Rushing Offense and Defense, Passing Offense, & Defense, Scoring Offense and Defense, Garbage Yards, Weather, Injuries, Home Field Edge, and Successful Unbalanced Attacks). Here is how each is reflected:

Strength of Opponent: Our ratings do not just take the opposing team's overall power rating into account. For example, Team A's defense vs the rush was rated at 119. They faced Team B and allowed "just" 256 yds rushing and **dropped 5 spots** in the national overall defensive ratings. However, Power Plays took into account their potent Opponents run attack and had forecasted the Team A yielding 289 yds. Due to the fact they did better than the forecast, Power Plays raised their rating to 112 even though they slipped in the national (straight yardage) rankings. Next time an announcer on TV tells you that a certain team is #3 in the country vs the run **you better check Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings and see how good a rush defense they really have!** The top twenty ratings in Power Ratings for each offensive and defensive category will be listed in each week's issue of Power Plays.

Garbage yards: These are yards that a team gains or allows in the final minutes of a game when it has been decided. For example, Team A is ahead 63-0 and allows 93 yards passing for a TD vs its fourth string defense. These yards are **counted** into national ratings, **but not in Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings!**

Weather: If a game is played in miserable weather conditions and is low scoring, the straight statistics credit the defense with outstanding performances. Our Power Ratings reflect the conditions and do not give excess credit to the defenses.

Injuries: When Missouri played Vanderbilt in '13, Tigers QB James Franklin was injured early in the game. His backup, who had seen very little action (rFr), was not prepared and hit on 30%, 9-30 passes. The offensive coordinator simplified the offense. In the national statistics Vanderbilt's overall defense **MOVED UP 8 NOTCHES**. In the Power Ratings they **went from #11 dropping out of the Top 15**, as the poor performance WAS NOT reflective of an outstanding performance by the defense.

Home Field Edges: The weekly projection of yards and points is weighted with the home field factored in.

Successful Unbalanced Attacks: A few Seasons ago, Tulsa was held to 155 yards passing vs Houston. This dropped Tulsa in the national passing offense ratings & RAISED the Cougars in the pass defense ratings. In our ratings the two units **remained** rated around the same. Why? Tulsa rushed for 350 yards & DID NOT HAVE TO RELY ON THE PASS & when they did they hit 18 of 32. While Houston's pass defense looked good in the national ratings, only Northcoast Sports' Power Ratings reflected the TRUTH!

There you have it. More than just numbers, THESE RATINGS REFLECT the true strength of each unit and allow them to have **the most accurate forecast of yards gained and points allowed in the country! No other rating system takes into account all the previous factors.** Next time you hear that a team is rated third in the country in pass defense, just remember, yards are not everything and Northcoast Sports' Power Plays will show you how strong the team really is.

NORTHCOAST SPORTS PLUS OR MINUS POWER RATINGS

The Power Ratings listed below are not based on the Power Plays, they are based on last year's final computer power rating numbers with the pluses and minuses from the off season changes factored in. They are then adjusted during the course of the season based on the final score of the games that are played on a weekly basis. The Power Ratings listed below can be used for you as a base power ratings to forecast up coming lines and strength of opponents, etc. Once again, they are not based on Power Plays and **they differ from what we have shown in recent years**, which has been our actual computer Power Ratings. These are Northcoast Sports Plus or Minus Power Ratings.

5th meeting and first since 1992. ECU won the last two in '91-'92. This is Pitt's 2nd trip to the Military Bowl, they lost to Navy in '15. HC Narduzzi is just 2-5 SU/ATS in bowls and lost LY's GameAbove Bowl to Toledo 48-46 (-6'). ECU is in the Military Bowl for the 2nd straight year. LY they beat NCSt here 26-21 (+7) and the Pirates have won their last 2 bowls.

Pitt lost their last 6 games in '24. They returned key portions of their roster this year at skill positions and on their front 7 including AA LB Kyle Louis. They were 2-0 when they blew DD 2H leads to WVU and Louisville. Pitt won their next 5 games as frosh QB Heintschel sparked the offense. They upset GTech on the road and lost to both Notre Dame and Miami at home to finish 8-4 but easily could have been 10-2. They are +55 ypg. Their D allows 337 ypg including just 97 rush (3.0). AA LB Louis left for the NFL and they may also be without All-ACC LB Biles. Pitt has excellent ST's (#16) and played the tougher sked (#55 vs #91). RB Reid has been hurt off and on and is a ? here and RB Goff went in the Portal.

HC Harrell has done an excellent job since being promoted last year. He got the Pirates to an 8-4 finish last year. They were 3-3 this year but the losses were at NCSt, vs BYU and at Tulane. EC won their next 4 games including a dominant trip to Temple when they had a 614-233 yd edge. The Pirates were in the mix for the AAC Title until their 58-24 loss at UTSA. EC ended the reg ssn with a 42-3 win over FAU. They are 8-4 SU/7-5 ATS and they are +117 ypg. However, the Pirates take a big hit here as QB Houser is in the Portal, WR Anthony Smith is a ? and both coordinators have departed. EC will either start journeyman QB Mike Wright or frosh Chaston Ditta. Either way the offense takes a step back against a tough Pitt defense.

PP's has Pitt by 5 but doesn't factor QB Hauser's opt out. The projected total is near the line so this is a no play.

FORECAST: NO PLAY **RATING: NO PLAY**

We would have expected this to be a playoff game, not the Pinstripe Bowl. This is Penn St's 2nd trip to the Pinstripe Bowl. They won here in '14 against BC 31-30 in OT. Clemson is making their first trip here. Dabo Swinney is 13-9 ATS in Bowls.

Penn St was a projected top 5 team and National Title contender entering '25. They started 3-0 against a weak sked. In a White Out in Happy Valley PSU lost to Oregon in OT. They were -24' vs UCLA yet lost 47-42 then -21 vs NW and lost 22-21 so HC Franklin was let go. PSU's losing streak extended to 6 with losses to Iowa and Ohio St but they showed signs of life when they nearly upset Indiana. Interim HC Terry Smith rallied his team with 3 straight wins to finish 6-6 and reach a bowl. Naturally with a coaching change ahead PSU has significant opt outs. RB Singleton, LG loane and four defensive starters have opted out while the status of RB Allen, WR Pena and LB Campbell are still undecided.

Clemson also had high expectations with QB Klubnik returning along with a top notch WR corps and an NFL caliber Dline. The offense had a slow start and they lost to LSU in the opener. They were 1-3 after losses to GTech and Syracuse. Clemson won B2B Blowouts at NC and BC but lost B2B again to SMU and Duke. The Tigers won their last 4 to finish 7-5 and they are +52 ypg. Clemson's opt outs include WR Williams, LG Sadler, DT Woods and Capehart, DE Parker, S Barnes and CB Terrell. WR Wesco and LB Woodaz are injured and won't play. All indications are that QB Klubnik is playing. Clemson's biggest edge is in the Coaching dept and DC Allen was at PSU LY and knows their personnel.

With so many opt outs it's hard to pick a winner here. Both tms finished strong. If RB Allen sits out then PSU will be without most of their offense. The Big 10 is 8-0 SU in the Pinstripe Bowl. Lets wait until we know who exactly is sitting this game out.

FORECAST: NO PLAY **RATING: NO PLAY**

10th mtg but first time in a Bowl game. UConn is 5-4 SU vs Army but Army has won the last 2 in '21 & '22. This is the 4th Fenway Bowl. UConn won this game just last year when they beat North Carolina 27-14. Army's Jeff Monken is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS in bowls. Army has won 6 of their L/7 bowls including LY's Independence Bowl over LA Tech 27-6 (-14). UConn's Interim HC is OC Gordon Sammis.

UConn went 9-3 last year and returned their top skill players including QB Fagnano, RB Edwards and WR Bell. They nearly upset Syracuse (lost in OT) then gave up a late td to lose to Delaware. UConn won 8 of their last 9 to finish 9-3 and are +46 ypg. Their best win was over ACC Champs Duke and all 3 of their losses were by 7 or less. HC Mora left for Colorado St. QB Fagnano is sitting this game out but RB Edwards and WR Bell will play. They have 3 OL and 3 defensive starters in the portal but WR Bell is trying to convince them to play. UConn has seen the option this year when they beat Air Force late in the ssn. Backup QB Evers was highly recruited (orig Wisky) and started 8 games here LY.

Army blew a 14 pt lead and was upset by Tarleton St in their opener. The following week they upset Kansas St. They lost their first two AAC games but they won 5 of their next 7. Army lost to their arch rival, Navy, 17-16 in the ssn finale to finish 6-7 and they are -26 ypg. The Army offense hasn't been the explosive unit it was LY. They only avg 22 ppg/324 ypg and are being held 87 ypg under what their opp's allow on avg. Their D allows 350 ypg and holds foes 56 ypg but that's partly because their offense controls the clock with slow drives so well.

This line opened UConn -3' and now stands Army -6' because of UConn's opt outs but the only one that for sure isn't playing is QB Fagnano. PP's had UConn winning by 6 but that's with Fagnano playing. We will downgrade slightly but this is a big lean on the Huskies!

BYU has won last 3 mtgs in '03,'12 & '13. This is Cougar HC Kalani Sitake's 8th bowl in 10 yrs. He's 5-2 SU & 4-3 ATS, beating #20 Colorado (-3), 36-14, in LY's Alamo Bowl. GT is playing 3rd straight bowl for HC Brent Key. Yellow Jackets (+5) beat UCF, 30-17, in '23 and lost to Vandy (+3) in LY's Birmingham Bowl, 35-27.

BYU has won 11 gms in b2b yrs and was 9-4 ATS. Their only losses were to Texas Tech, in Lubbock and in the Big 12 title gm. They won at Arizona and Cincy and beat rival Utah while staying in the CFP hunt all yr. Cougs are +13 ppg and +69 ypg against our #15 sked. The offense revolves around the running of LJ Martin (1305, 5.3) and frosh QB Bear Bachmeier (64%, 2708, 14-6, 527 rush). The rec's have a big edge on GT pass D which ranks 87th with 18-3 ratio. D holds opp 64 ypg below avg (#25 FBS) and allows just 122 rush ypg (3.7). Pass D ranks #11 with a 15-16 ratio. OLB Jack Kelly has more sacks (10) than GT has allowed all yr (9).

GT opened 8-0 and rose to #8 in polls before an upset at NC St, 48-36. That loss set off a rough 1-3 SU & ATS finish with the only win by 2 over 2-10 BC. Jackets +8 ppg and +69 ypg against our #61 sked. The offense gains 71 ypg above opp avg (#20 FBS) and is #19 in FBS rushing at 203 ypg and 5.6 ypc. QB Haynes King makes the offense go. He leads with 922 rushing (5.2) and has thrown for 2697 (72%, 12-5). However, off staff has been gutted incl loss of OC Buster Faulkner to Florida. The D showed cracks and allows 28ypg above opp avg (#93 FBS), but did hold Georgia to just 16 pts and 260 yds in the finale. GT's 3 INT's rank 130th in FBS.

Computer has BYU winning 32-22. We agree. Cougars have big edge on defense, and King & GT will miss Faulkner's playcalling. Jackets ran out of gas in November and that trend will continue in December. BYU is laying small number here compared to their overall personnel advantages and we expect them to win by DD.

First mtg. In HC Chuck Martin's 12 yrs at Miami (OH), he's 2-4 SU in bowls but 6-0 ATS and 5-1 to the under! RedHawks beat Colorado St (+2), 43-17, in LY's Arizona Bowl. Fresno St has been to 4 straight bowl (3-1 SU & 2-2 ATS) but has not played here. Bulldogs lost to MAC's NIU, 28-20, in LY's Potato Bowl. HC Matt Entz led North Dakota St to 5 straight FCS playoffs but this is his 1st bowl gm.

Martin has led Miami to 3 straight MAC title gms, winning in '23 and losing last 2. They opened 0-3 with losses to Wisconsin, Rutgers and UNLV of the MWC. They regrouped with 5 wins in a row, incl over WMU, but QB Dequan Finn led the tm after a loss to Ohio and the offense tanked vs Toledo. RedHawks rallied for wins over Buffalo & Ball St but lost the rematch with WMU. Finn's replacements are completing just 43% and top WR Kam Perry (966, 23.0) is opting out. The offense is an issue but the D is not, even though top DL Adam Trick won't play. Miami allows 22ppg and 330ypg and leads the MAC with 40 sacks. They'll also have a ST's edge (#8 vs #24).

Entz raised the bar in his 1st ssn in the Valley. Fresno went from 6 to 8 wins incl a 30-7 rout of nemesis Boise St. Bulldogs hit a midseason lull and lost 4 straight ATS but rebounded to go 3-1 SU & ATS. They're +56 ypg against our #112 sked, and like Miami have relied on the D to bail out an ineffective and INT-prone offense. Fresno gains 45 ypg below opp avg (#114 FBS) and QB EJ Warner has almost as many picks as TD's (12-11 ratio). Offense reached 400 yds just once in final 8 gms. However, the D allows just 20 ppg and holds opp 70 ypg below their avg (#22 FBS). It'll be a long day for the Miami QB's vs the 10th ranked D which has 19 INT's.

Forecast has Fresno 25-21. We disagree and have Miami winning a low-scoring battle between the PK's. Both QB's struggles will continue against proven D's. Plus, Martin always covers in bowls and this is Entz's 1st bowl. RedHawks by a FG so no play here.
