LOUISVILLE by 14 over Virginia Tech - Huge ACC Title game implications here. Since switching to QB Drones (6-1 ratio, 388 rush), VT has turned their season around. The Hokies are 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS in ACC play after absolutely crushing Syracuse last week 38-10 (-3). VT finished w/ a 318-0 rush yd edge. We cashed our 4★ Top Newsletter play in UL's 23-0 (-6) win over Duke (351-202 yd edge). UL has allowed just 247 ypg in their L/4. VT's wins have all come over weak foes and they are 0-3 SU, -16 ppg and -53 ypg on the road with losses to Rutgers and Marshall while UL is 4-0 SU/ATS, +21 ppg and +215 ypg including a win over Notre Dame. We have the Cardinals by 2 td's. VIRGINIA by 6 over Georgia Tech - UVA has won 3 straight in this series and the home team is 21-5 SU/19-6-1 ATS. We cashed a 3★ LPS on UVA's near upset of Miami, losing 29-26 (+18) in OT. The Cavaliers held Miami to a ssn low 276 yds. GT rushed for 348 yds LW vs NCar and has avg'd over 7 ypc in the L/2. UVA held Miami to 113 rush and is only allowing 165 (4.5) on the season. The Cavaliers have a huge edge on D (#35 vs #108) and GT has allowed 233 rush ypg (5.4)! GT is 1-4 SU off outright upsets under Key including a loss to Bowling Green earlier this year. We think UVA is way better than their 2-7 record and will go with series history, taking the home team. Navy by 10 over TEMPLE - Navy is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS vs Temple. Both tms enter fresh off a bye. Temple has yet to cover against an FBS foe (0-7 ATS) while Navy is 3-4 SU/2-5 ATS this year. The Middies do have wins over CLT and NTexas. Temple was w/o QB Warner in their last 2 and lost by 31 & 55. Warner does have a 12-5 ratio so the offense is improved if he is healthy? (this wk). Temple is allowing 207 rush (4.9) so we will give Navy, who is 12-6 as an AF the L9Y, a 10 pt edge. Iowa by 10 over NORTHWESTERN - The Cats are returning back to Wrigley Field for the 1st time since '21 when they fell to Purdue 32-14 (+11). Iowa meanwhile heads into the home of the Cubs for the 1st time (33-13 hm win over NW LY as 11' pt chalk). The Hawkeyes are 23-6-1 ATS as an AF incl 2-0 ATS TY. While they're also off a bye, they did lose on a controversial ruling on a PR TD late in 4th vs Minn 2 wks ago. NW coming off a home win vs MD where QB Sullivan threw for 265 yds. The Cats have covered their L/3 neutral matchups and should stay within the line here against an Iowa squad that's averaging a porous 14 ppg and 191 ypg in conf play TY. All of Iowa's wins are by at least 6 points which is where this game opened and we have the Hawkeyes by DD's! James Madison by 6 over GEORGIA ST - JMU has won both prior mtgs vs GSt. LY JMU trailed 34-14 HT but JMU came back 2H to win 42-40 (+168 yds, +13 FD's). GSt's run game has been the strength of their offense (191, 4.8) but goes up against a stout JMU run D that allowing just 49 rush ypg (1.6) and the pass rush has 39 sks (12%). Against 3 common SBC foes (Troy, MU, GSthm) JMU is 3-0 SU/ATS +74 ypg while GSt is 1-2 SU/ATS -53 ypg. JMU has big edges on offense (#55/#85), defense (#42/#80), and ST (#21/#93). We'll call for JMU to keep their unbeaten season alive and win here by just under a td. MINNESOTA by 3 over Illinois - The Illini have had B2B SU & ATS upsets against the Gophers. LY Illini pulled off a +292 yd edge, were +3 TOs and held UM to just 38 yds passing. LTH the Illini pulled off a 14-6 upset win (+14). Illinois is fresh off a bye and are 7-3 ATS as an AD the L2Y. The Gophers meanwhile picked up a 15 pt win LW vs Mich St with RB Nubin and 40 carries for 204 yds and 2 td's. Prior to LW the Illini had an outright upset win at MD (+13) and led the Badgers in the 4Q before falling w/27 left. QB Altmeyer has looked better w/a 61% (6-2 ratio) over the L/4. We originally thought Minnesota was going to be over a td favorite but the Gophers are only laying 3 and while Illinois is a dangerous dog here, we put this right at the line. BAYLOR by 7 over Houston - 29th meeting between former SWC foes, but have not met since 1995! BU was held to just 306 yds in a 30-18 lost vs ISU, while Hou was blown out 41-0 at KSt LW (-186 yds, -13 FD's). Houston has the #104 pass D and since coming back from inj BU QB Shapen is avg'g 293 pass ypg (60%, 4-1 ratio). These tms match up evenly on paper, but both of BU's wins in Big 12 play are vs newcomers (UCF, Cincy) and in B12 play Hou is -103 ypg while BU is -67 ypg and we'll call for the Bears to get the home win as they look to keep bowl hopes alive. Oregon St by 7 over COLORADO - The Buffs didn't have much success in their return from bye as the Bruins held them to just 242 yds and 16 pts while recording 7 sks. Colorado now returns to Boulder to take on an OSU squad that was tripped up by 3 LW in Tucson despite a 407-363 yd edge. In their Corvallis meeting a year ago the Beavers (-23') finished with 26-17 FD and 472-290 yd edges in the 42-9 victory. The home team in this series is 8-2 ATS which includes a 37-34 (+11) upset by the Buffs the year prior. While OSU has been dominant at home with a 16-1 ATS run (+140 ypg TY in Corvallis), they are just 3-9 ATS as away chalk. With Colorado being involved in plenty of one score games, the HD gets the edge in this one. UTAH by 7 over Arizona St - The Utes saw their 18-gm home winning streak snapped in blowout fashion LW against the Ducks who held them to just 6 pts and 241 yds in a 29 pt defeat (Ute QB Barnes 15-29-136-0-2). Utah now faces off with a Sun Devils squad that nearly pulled the outright upset 2 wks ago in Seattle against undefeated Washington (led 7-3 in 4Q). ASU continued their

solid play LW at home vs WSU as they snapped an 8-gm P12 losing skid finishing with a 509-403 yd edge. This is a very underrated Sun Devils D, holding foes to 341 ypg and is #12 in the FBS, holding foes 87 ypg below their average. While we do expect Utah to get back on track here, they do have a crucial road trip to Seattle on deck. With ASU 12-4 ATS as an AD the L6Y and ASU holding foes to 87 ypg under their avg (#12), we're cutting off our line at a td. ARIZONA by 3 over UCLA - The Wildcats have been an ATS darling for '23 with LW's upset of the Beavers being their 7th cover in 8 tries where won a 3★ LP play on the Wildcats! (consec wins over Top 25 tms, QB Fifita 2 TD passes in 4Q). They're now back in Tucson for a 2nd straight week to take on a UCLA squad that grabbed a 12 pt home win vs Colorado where their def recorded a ssn-best 7 sks (487-242 yd edge). In their Pasadena meeting LY the Bruins (-20) suffered a surprising 34-28 defeat despite 26-22 FD and 464-436 yd edges. While UCLA has gone 8-3 SU/ATS vs Arizona s/'12, the series favorite has failed to cover 4 of the L/6. Arizona HC Fisch (interim HC at UCLA in '17) has his team in the mix for their 1st bowl since 2017! OREGON by 32 over California - The Ducks return home following a surprising 35-6 win LW in SLC where they held the Utes to just 13 FD's and 241 yds. The Bears meanwhile head North after their 5th straight ATS loss (1-4 SU) LW in Berkeley against the Trojans who they actually led by 2 TD's in the 4Q and finished with 29-20 FD and 527-497 yd edges (4-1 TO deficit, missed GW 2 pt at w/:58 left). In their Bay Area meeting a year ago, the Ducks (-17) overcame an early 2Q deficit in the eventual 42-24 win (UO 31-21 FD & 586-402 yd edges). While Cal is an impressive 13-5 ATS as an AD, they have dropped 7 straight (2-5 ATS) at Autzen. The Ducks have outscored their 3 FBS opponents by 32 ppg at home this year while going 8-2 ATS in Eugene under HC Lanning the L2Y. We think Oregon might be the most complete team in the country so they win big. Washington by 1 over USC - The Trojans return home after picking up a 50-49 shootout win (trailed by 14 early 4Q) LW in Berkeley to end their 2-game losing skid (QB Williams 23-40-369-2-0, 2 rush TD). The undefeated Huskies meanwhile begin a rough 3-game stretch (home vs Utah & at Oregon St on deck) following a narrow 9 pt win LW in Palo Alto (-27'). Surprisingly, this is the 1st matchup between these 2 since '19 when the Huskies (-10') jumped out to an early 2 TD lead in the 28-14 Seattle victory. While the dog has covered 5 of the L/7 including 4 outright upsets and Washington is just 2-8 ATS as away chalk, keep in mind that Huskies Heisman hopeful Penix (369 pass yds & 4 TD's) could have a field day against a USC pass D that has our #93 ranking (22 all'd TD passes TY, 3rd most in FBS!). WASHINGTON ST by 17 over Stanford - WSU extended their SU/ATS losing streak to 4 in a row LW in Tempe despite another big day from QB Ward (350 ttl yds & 3 TD's). They now return to Pullman to take on a Cardinal squad that surprisingly kept LW's home meeting against the undefeated Huskies close (trailed by 2 late 4Q, 495-460 yd edge). WSU has dominated the recent series with a 6-0 SU/ATS mark (17 pt avg MOV) including a 52-14 (-4) victory LY on "The Farm" where they finished with a 514-337 yd edge. After an embarrassing 44-6 defeat against Arizona (outgained 516-234!) the last time they played in the Palouse, we're expecting the Cougs to put forth one of their best efforts of the year (WSU on a 14-8-1 ATS run vs P12 foes)! SAN DIEGO ST by 1 over Utah St - Last met in the 2021 MW title game, where USU (+6) pulled the outright upset, winning 46-13 here. Both teams enter off a bye & SDST needed to regroup after losing 6-0 to a then winless Nevada team & sit at just 3-5. USU also sits at 3-5 and have dropped their L/2 MW gms. USU has the big edge on offense (#43/#119) as SDST is avg'g just 312 ypg in MW play and are allowing 400 ypg in MW play, while USU is avg'g 443 ypg in MW play. USU QB Legas DNP last game, but with a week off should be back & in his L/2 starts has B2B 300+ yd pass gms. We'll call for SDST to win, but we expect the Aggies to keep it close. Charlotte by 1 over TULSA - First mtg. CLT lost at home on Fri Night 38-16 (+3) and HC Poggi suspended a group of players following the game. Tulsa was decimated at SMU last week in a 69-10 (+20) loss where they trailed 52-3 at half! CLT has the edge on defense, holding foes to just 276 ypg in their L/4 and the 49ers are actually +36 ypg vs AAC foes while Tulsa is -98 and they've been outscored 111-20 in their last two but the Hurricane are the favorite. Poggi hasn't announced who is suspended but we would rather take the better defense as an underdog to win this game. IOWA ST by 7 over Kansas - LY's 14-11 win by KU snapped a 7 gm SU win streak for ISU, so the Cyclones will be out for revenge. KU is off an upset vs OU 38-33 while ISU beat BU 30-18. ISU has the big edge on defense (#15/#75) as they are holding foes to 67 ypg under their avg (#21) and they have the #4 pass D (11-13 ratio), while KU is allowing 478 ypg in B12 play are allowing foes to gain 22 ypg above their avg (#101). KU also has the #89 pass D and ISU QB Becht has improved during B12 play, as he has a 9-3 ratio. ISU should get their run gm going too vs a KU run D allowing 207 (5.1) in B12 play. KU is in a prime spot for a letdown & Ames at night is a tough atmosphere and ISU is 4-1 SU/ATS in B12 play this season.

OKLAHOMA ST +6 over Oklahoma

OKLAHOMA ST vs Oklahoma - Last meeting of Bedlam currently scheduled with OU moving to the SEC next ssn. Okla St is off a 45-13 win where they put up 601 yds and we picked up a 5* Oct GOM winner on the Pokes! OU is off an upset loss at KU 38-33 and have had 2 subpar gms after their upset win of Texas. Okla St is led by RB Gordon who now leads the FBS in rushing (1087, 7.7, 10 td) and he has 553 yds (10.2) the L/2 gms! OU's rush D just allowed KU to rush for 225 (5.5) LW. Okla St is on a 6-1 ATS run as a B12 home dog & have actually pulled the outright upset 8 of the L/10 times they were a home dog incl 2 this season, and we will call for the Pokes to pull off their 3rd Big 12 home upset of the season!

Louisiana by 13 over ARKANSAS ST - LA has won 5 straight vs Ark St (3-2 ATS) and LY at home LA (-6) win 38-18. LA is off a 33-20 upset at SALA despite being -150 yds as they were +5 TO's while Ark St beat ULM 34-24. Ark St currently has our #127 defense & are allowing foes to gain 64 ypg above their avg (#127) and after being held to 318 ypg the L/2 wks, LA's offense, which put up 400+ yds in 5 of their F/6 gms should move the ball, especially on the ground as they avg 215 ypg (5.6) and Ark St is allg 230 rush (5.7) vs SBC foes. Ark St has 4 wins but those tms are a comb'd 5-28 and are -103 ypg in SBC play. Give us the Cajuns by nearly 2 full td's.

ALABAMA by 3 over Lsu - Bama is out for revenge after losing 32-31 at LSU last year. The Tide have a big edge on defense, holding foes 115 ypg below their avg (#7 in FBS) while LSU is allowing 21 ypg more than their foes avg. Bama will look to slow down an LSU offense that has pushed all 8 of their games Over the Total. Jayden Daniels actually has a higher ypc (11.5) than Joe Burrow did in '19 (10.8) and the Tigers 553 ypg is #1 in the FBS! With both teams having such clear edges, we can see this being a close game down to the final possession. Saban is 17-1 SU/12-6 ATS in revenge games including their win over Tenn. We have Bama winning but LSU is 16-5-1 as an SEC Dog so our lean is on the dog.

MEMPHIS by 17 over Usf - Memphis has won L/2 mtgs but they didn't meet the L2Y. Memphis is 39-7 SU at home since '17 but are 0-3-1 ATS this year. USF is fresh off a bye and at 4-4 SU/ATS this year but all 4 losses have come by at least 2 td's. Memphis is -20 ypg vs AAC foes while USF is -32 ypg vs AAC foes and the Bulls are getting 2 td's here. Memphis has the edge in all 3 phases so we will call for the Tigers to cover at home for the first time this year and win by over 2 td's.

Smu by 7 over RICE - These two met every year from 1989-2012 until SMU left CUSA but now they meet as AAC rivals. Rice has covered the last 7 mtgs. The Owls came through as our 3rd straight Underdog POW winner, only losing 30-28 vs Tulane (+10)! SMU led Tulsa 52-3 w/a 440-110 yd edge at half LW! Mustangs QB Preston Stone has an 8-0 ratio in his L/3. SMU is 4-0 in AAC play and is outscoring conf foes by 38 ppg (+225 ypg)! Rice is +6 ppg in AAC play but -47 ypg. Rice already has a win over Houston at home and SMU's 4 conference wins have come against weak foes and their 21 pt win at EC was misleading. We think Rice puts up a solid figt.

Florida Atlantic by 3 over Uab - CUSA transplants meet as AAC foes for the first time. FAU is 4-4 SU/4-3-1 ATS this season while the Blazers are 2-6 SU/4-4 ATS and fresh off a bye. UAB is actually +12 ypg while FAU is -40 ypg and UAB has faced the tougher sked (#71 vs #93). UAB is also +39 ypg vs AAC foes and none of those opponents have a losing record. FAU did beat CLT last week 38-16 (-3'). UAB QB Zeno was inj'd and missed their last game but could be back from the bye week. UAB has allowed 201 rush (5.3) while FAU has had 3 games where they rushed for over 200 yds. We will take the Owls to win by a fg.

Um by 1 over SOUTHERN MISS - 4th meeting since 2017 and the home team is 0-3 SU/ATS. In LY's meeting as SBC foes SMISS led 10-7 HT (273-82) and won 20-10 (+216 yds). SMISS showed some life LW and led App St at HT, but lost 48-38 and now have lost 7 straight (1-6 ATS) while ULM has lost 6 straight gms (3-3 ATS) after their 34-24 loss vs Ark St last week. Both teams have struggled the L/4 wks as ULM is -126 ypg/-17 ppg while SMISS is -112 ypg/-20 ppg. ULM has covered 4 of their L/5 SBC road games and we like them here to get the win.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 6 over Kentucky - The home team is 8-0 SU/ATS in this series with the last 5 games being decided by 24 ppg. KY is 0-15 SU on the road vs the SEC West including 0-11 under Stoops. Miss St couldn't muster up enough offense to beat Auburn on the road last week but they return home and could get Will Rogers back at QB. KY's 33-27 (+3) home loss to Tenn was their 3rd straight loss and they are -101 ypg in their L/4. This is only the 'Cats 3rd road game this year. A win here for MSU puts them in great shape to get to a bowl and they've played a tougher sked (#22 vs #63).

FLORIDA by 10 over Arkansas - The Gators have never lost to Ark in The Swamp (avg MOV 23 ppg). The Hogs are also 0-8 SU/2-6 ATS vs the SEC East. FL couldn't match up with UGA in a 43-20 loss but the Gators have won 3 of the L/4 after losing to the Dawgs including the last meeting in '20 when FL won 63-35 (-16). Ark is 16-6-1 ATS as a Dog under Pittman and have 5 close losses on the season. They fired their OC after putting up 3 pts and 200 yds vs Miss St prior to their bye. FL is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS at home this year and we don't see Ark staying as close this time.

Texas A&M by 3 over MISSISSIPPI - Ole Miss has won the last two mtgs. LY the Rebels trailed 14-10 at half but won 31-28 (-2). A&M had a 167-49 yd edge and led SCar 21-7 at half LW but settled for fg's in the 2H and only won 30-17 (-16). The Rebels are off a 33-7 (-24) home win over Vandy. Ole Miss has the edge on offense (#12 vs #47) but A&M has the edge on defense (#5 vs #27) and a big edge on ST's (#20 vs #70). A&M's two road losses this year were against Miami and Tenn so they aren't over their heads here and we think the better defense prevails.

TEXAS by 3 over Kansas St - While Texas has won 6 straight vs KSt, 5 of those 6 were decided by 7 points or less. KSt continued their winning ways LW as they won 41-0 vs Hou (+186 yds) while Texas won 35-6 over BYU with backup QB Murphy leading the way. While Texas stops the run well (99, 3.4 vs B12) KSt's rush attack is putting up 259 ypg (5.8) and both QB's Howard and Johnson are dual-threat. KSt is holding teams to 77 ypg under their avg (#18) and are holding tms to just 109 rush (3.7) and KSt has the #7 pass D (7-7 ratio) and face a QB making just his 2nd start. KSt is on a 11-4 ATS run in the Big 12 and we expect them to keep this game close.

NEVADA by 10 over Hawaii - Hawaii has won & covered 3 of the L/4 mtgs vs Nevada. After losing 16 straight gms, Nevada has won & covered 2 straight gms after beating NMex LW 34-24 despite being -89 yds (+3 TO's). UH dropped their 4th straight both SU/ATS as they were shutout 35-0 at home vs SJSU LW (-270 yds, -2 TO's). Nevada has solid edges on both defense (#85 vs #123) and schedule strength (#66 vs #92). While UH and Nev are both -71 ypg vs MW foes, Nev is just -5 ppg and UH is -22 ppg and UH is -11 TO's in MW play while Nev is +1. Hawaii will also have to deal with the colder weather and altitude at Nev as well. Hawaii doesn't have much to play for & has zero momentum while Nev seems to have found something the last couple wks & we like them to win and cover here to make it 3 SU/ATS wins in a row!

LIBERTY by 20 over Louisiana Tech - First mtg. Lib is now 8-0 SU/6-2 this year and has a shot at a NY6 Bowl if they win out but with a weak schedule they need style points. The Flames are +138 ypg this year while LT is +8. LT enters on a 3 game losing streak, though all 3 losses came by 8 points or less. Lib beat WKU 42-29 (-5) on the road last week. Their offense is putting up 488 ypg and 109 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. A loss here ends LT's bowl hopes and we can see Lib adding a late score to cover.

NEW MEXICO ST by 7 over Middle Tennessee - These two last met as Sun Belt foes in 2004. The home team won all 4 previous mtgs. NMSt is bowl eligible at 6-3 SU/6-2-1 ATS this year and with only 1 conference loss they have a shot at the CUSA Title game if they beat WKU next week. MT is clinging to bowl hopes at 2-6 SU but are fresh off a bye. They did only lose 42-35 at Liberty 2 wks ago. NMSt is +21 ypg in CUSA play while MT is -22 and NMSt is actually 11-3 as a HF s'19!
Unlv by 6 over NEW MEXICO - The home team in this series is on a 1-5 SU/0-6 ATS run. LW UNLV outgained Fresno 424-312 but lost 31-24 as they were -2 TO's while NMex outgained Nev 400-311 but lost 34-24 (-3 TO's). NMex has struggled against the run in MW play, allowing 184 (5.8) and UNLV is putting up 215 rush (4.7) in conf play. UNLV is also +91 ypg in MW play while NMex is -10 ypg. UNLV's run D is holding tms to 121 (3.7) while NMex was held to just 83 rush (2.6) LW against a worse Nev run D. UNLV is off a tough loss now are a DD favorite & NMex is desperate for a win so we expect them to keep this game close.

TEXAS ST by 1 over Georgia Southern - A battle of 6-2 teams here. As SBC foes TXSt is 0-5 SU vs GSthrn but have covered 3 of the 5 mtgs. TXSt is off a home loss to Troy where they had a 437-420 yd edge but were -4 TO's and lost 31-13. TXSt does have the #107 pass D and GSthrn throws for 301 ypg (60%) in SBC play. However, GSthrn is allowing 279 pass ypg in SBC play and TXSt QB Finley (2104 yds) is hitting 68% with a 15-5 ratio and TXSt is also running for 203 ypg (5.2) and GSthrn's D overall is allowing 431 ypg in SBC play. With 2 strong offenses we look for a lot of points and for TXSt to pull out a close win after battling the SBC's best tough this ssn.

MICHIGAN by 35 over Purdue - Since '99 Michigan is 11-3 SU (10-4 ATS) vs Purdue with the winner of the matchup covering 9 of L/10. In LY's B10 Champ game UM (-16) only led 14-13 at HT but pulled away for a 43-22 win (Purdue 27-17 FD & 456-386 yd edges!). The Wolverines are avg 46 ppg in B10 play with Heisman contender QB McCarthy (18-3 ratio) while their def is allowing just 6 ppg overall! We can't see going against Michigan and Purdue was just held to a ssn low 195 yards LW and the week prior they lost at home to OSU 41-7. Michigan does have Penn St on deck but we can't go against the most dominant team in the country.

Notre Dame by 6 over CLEMSON - ND's dominance over the ACC (30-1 SU/22-9 ATS) continued last week with their 58-7 (-20) win over Pitt. The Irish finished w/a 535-255 yd edge and had a PR td, a pick-6 and a fumble ret td. Things got worse for Clemson LW in their 24-17 (-9) at NCSt. They did hold a 364-202 yd edge but Klubnik threw 2 int's (incl a pick-6) and they missed a fg. Clemson is looking to avoid their first 3 game losing streak since 2010, Dabo's 2nd full season. The Irish are +8 TO's in their last 2 and Clemson has been turnover prone which could be the difference.

Wku by 3 over UTEP - WKU has won all 3 previous meetings with the last in '18. The 'Toppers still need two wins to get bowl eligible but their game next week vs NMSt has big CUSA Title gm implications. WKU's defense is allowing 219 rush ypg (5.0) which could be a big issue against UTEP's physical Oline and RB's Hankins and Burgess. UTEP can still reach a bowl if they win out and they are +27 ypg in CUSA play while WKU is only -13. LW's come-from-behind win over SH built confidence for UTEP and we think they stay within a fg at home.

Boise St by 3 over FRESNO ST - Boise has won and covered 3 of the L/4 meetings vs Fresno, however their last mtg was the '22 MW title game that Fresno (+3) won outright 28-16. Boise is off their best performance of the ssn vs WY as they won 32-7 and held WY to 112 yds and 8 FD's while putting up 443 yds incl 227 rush (4.5) and RB Holani made his return & ran for 75 yds LW. Fresno won 31-24 vs UNLV despite being -112 yds (+2 TO's) and are -9 ypg in MW play, while Boise is +85 ypg in MW play. Fresno does have a solid D (341 ypg/21 ppg) but Boise may have turned a corner LW and we expect them to continue their momentum from LW ang get the road upset here!

Ohio at BUFFALO - Both are trying to stay in the MAC East race... Home Team is 11-1 SU & 9-2 ATS but Ohio is 3-1 SU & ATS s'18. After opening 0-4 Buffalo won 3 of L/4 SU & covered 4 of L/5 heading into last Tuesday's trip to Toledo. After opening the season with a 20-13 loss at SDSU, Ohio won 6 of next 7 but LW, in a showdown with Miami for the lead in the MAC East lost 30-16 as a 7' pt HF. Ohio has struggled in the Redzone, in 32 trips they have just 16 td settling for 10 FG & has scored over 20 pts in just 3 gms but have allowed over 20 pts just twice. Buffalo has scored over 20 in 4 games (15.1 ppg) but has allowed over 20 in 5 & 38+ in 4 of those (28.9 ppg).

Ball St at NORTHERN ILLINOIS - Home Team has won L/3. After winning 10 straight in series from '09-'18 NIU has lost 3 of L/4 (2-2 ATS) including a 44-38 loss LY as a 4' pt AF despite a 526-480 yd edge Both are off mid-week games, Ball St may still be playing with slim bowl hopes, while NIU is also trying to become bowl eligible they are still in the MAC West race. Huskies have the edge on both Offense (#87 #129) & Defense (#70 #83) but heading into LW's game at Central Michigan was just 1-3 ATS as a Favorite, while in LW's game at BG, Ball St is just 2-4-1 as a dog.

Central Michigan at WESTERN MICHIGAN - These Rivals play for the Victory Canon & the winner will also win the Michigan MAC Trophy as WM beat EM in their last game 45-21 as a 3 pt AF. & CM beat EM 26-23 AS A 9' PT HF earlier this season 'While Chippewas have a slight defensive edge (#109 #115), Broncos have a big offensive edge (#63 #117). While that would have us leaning with WM the Visitor is 8-2 SU & has covered 10 straight!!
