KEY SELECTIONS

4★ UCF over Cincinnati - CIN has won 3 str in the series (2-1 ATS), incl a 56-21 (-21) drubbing LY in Cincy, in which they outg'd UCF 476-296. The Bearcats have won 6 str TY, after their 29-27 (-3) road win at SMU, but have failed to cover in their L/3 & are now just 2-5 ATS TY. CIN had leads of 17-0 & 29-14, but all'd the Mustangs to hang around despite holding them to 259 tti yds. The CIN Def has now held 4 of their L/5 opps under 80 rush yds & are top 5 in the NCAA with 29 sks. UCF is off a 34-13 (-5) loss at East Carolina, which moved them to 5-2 (4-3 ATS). The Knights were outg'd 458-426 & turned the ball over 4 times, but are still gaining 119 yds more than their opps allow (#8). The home team is on a 6-1 ATS run in the series & the "Bounce House" should literally be rocking for this one, so we like the Knights to end the Bearcats 19 gm AAC win streak. The curse of the Power Sweep 4★ has plagued us all year but we called in an exorcist in the form of the Knights to break this awful streak.

FORECAST: UCF by 10

3★ IOWA ST over Oklahoma - Since Matt Campbell took over at ISU, the Cyclones are 5-2 ATS vs Oklahoma with a pair of outright upsets & the L/6 gms have all been decided by 7 pts or less. Both teams come into this game off a bye. Going back as far as our records go (1976) we cannot find a time where ISU was favored over OU, so this could very well be the 1st time if the line flips. Against 3 common B12 foes (Tex, KU, KSt) ISU is +9 ypg/-2 ppg while OU is -26 ypg/-15 ppg. While ISU is 0-4 SU in B12 play all 4 losses are by 1 score & their DEF is holding foes to 128 ypg under their ssn avg (#4 FBS). The ISU offense showed some life against Texas (329 pass yds) and here take on an OU DEF that is giving up 548 ypg/47 ppg against B12 foes and they have the #123 pass defense. The Sooners lone B12 win was over a beat up KU team while they lost 49-0 to Texas while ISU nearly upset UT. ISU is the slight dog as of presstime & HC Campbell is 10-3-1 ATS here as a HD & we'll call for ISU to get the win as they have been the more consistent team this season.

FORECAST: IOWA ST by 7

3★ Notre Dame over SYRACUSE - ND is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in this series since 2014 and the Irish have won all 3 meetings vs Babers by 24.7 ppg. Cuse didn't play nearly as well as the final score indicated last week in their 27-21 loss at Clemson. The Orange were outgained 450-291 but were +3 TO's and the game largely swung when Clemson's QB fumbled at the Cuse3 and the Orange ret'd it 97 yds for a 14 pt swing and a devastating blow to our 5★ GOM (UGH!). Cuse was missing CB Williams and lost multiple defensive starters during the game. ND is only off UNLV and won 44-21 (-26). ND has rushed for 224 (5.0) in their last 4 and Cuse allowed 293 rush (4.9) last week. RB Tucker only had 5 carries while battling a leg inj. ND has played a massively tougher sked (#10 vs #85) and have won their last 25 regular ssn games vs ACC teams so we are taking the Irish by a td over a beat up Syracuse team. Our Key Selections have been cursed recently but who better to go to than the luck of the Irish to change our fortunes!

FORECAST: Notre Dame by 8

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ SAN JOSE ST over Nevada - As MW foes SJSt is just 2-7 SU vs Nevada but have covered 4 of the L/6 games. This will be just the 3rd time in the L/9 meetings that SJSt is the favorite. SJSt was supposed to play LW at NMST but the game was postponed after a SJSt player was tragically killed so SJSt's last game was a loss 2 wks ago at Fresno St. Nev's woes continued as they have lost 6 games in a row both SU/ATS with all but 1 loss coming by less than 2 td's. The SJSt defense has been a strong point all ssn as they are holding foes to 85 ypg under their ssn avg while Nev is avg'g just 255 ypg vs FBS foes and are putting up 116 ypg less than their foes allow (#125 FBS). The Nev DEF has faced the #124 schedule but are allowing foes to gain 53 ypg above their season average (#115 FBS). SJSt's offense has picked up its performance in MW play, as they are avg'g 407 ypg led by QB Cordeiro (1602, 57%, 7-1) who also has 6 rush td TY. Nev is clearly a team to play against right now so we don't mind laying big points with SJSt here.

FORECAST: SAN JOSE ST by 34

2★ EASTERN MICHIGAN (+) over Toledo - Winner will be MAC West leader as Toledo leads West at 3-1 but EM is 2-2 their 2 wins over the other 2 tms that are also 2-2, so a win here would give them the tiebreaker over all 3. Eagles are 2-4 SU vs Rockets but are 5-1 ATS all as a dog. That incl LY when UT won 52-49 but EM covered as a 9 pt AD. LW as a 2' pt AD EM trailed Ball St 16-10 into the 4Q but scored the final 10 for a 20-16 outright upset. Toledo after benefiting from 4 int's in their win over NIU had a meltdown LW with 4 int's of their own (6 TO overall). They led Buffalo 27-10 into 4Q but lost 34-27 as a 7 pt AF. QB Finn, the heart of UT's Off (240 pass, 66 rush) was injured on the final play throwing for the EZ (4th int) & had to be helped off field (check status). While Finn's availability, could affect the line UT has opened as over a td fav and we love EM in the role of the dog as EM in their last 9 reg ssn gms as a dog is not only 6-3 ATS but 6-3 SU.

FORECAST: Toledo by 1

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY OCTOBER 27TH

Virginia Tech at NC STATE - VTech is 5-0 SU/ATS in this series including a 45-24 (-6) win in '20. Both teams are off a bye. The Hokies have lost 4 straight and are -105 ypg vs ACC foes. NCSt played their first game w/o QB Leary and lost 24-9 (+3) at Syracuse. The 'Pack were held to 255 yds with Charleston Southern transfer Jack Chambers finishing 18-30-160. Both tms are stronger on D, with VT holding foes to 357 ypg and 35 ypg below their avg while NCSt allows 311 ypg and holds their foes 103 ypg below their avg (#12 in FBS). NCSt is #8 in our pass D rankings, allowing 58% with a 7-11 ratio and VT QB Wells has thrown 7 int's this year. VT is 0-3 SU/ATS and -105 ypg on the road while NCSt is 4-0 SU/2-2 ATS and +139 ypg at home. A win here gives VT a decent shot at a bowl thanks to a weak remaining sked.

Louisiana at SOUTHERN MISS - Tms have met 51 times, with the last one coming in 2016 in the New Orleans Bowl (SMiss win 28-21). First time meeting as SBC foes. LA is off a 38-18 win vs Ark St where QB Wooldrige threw for 316 yds & 5 td! SMiss LW got a 53 yd td pass w/ 32 sec left 4Q to beat TXSt 20-14 (3★ Under LP winner!). SMiss has struggled offensively TY, getting held to 65 ypg under what their foes allow (#116 FBS) and LA's DEF has been solid TY, giving up 343 ypg/19 ppg. SMiss is holding SBC foes to 289 ypg and their DEF has 25 sks this ssn (10.7%), but LA's OL has all'd 11 sks (4.7%) & their offense went off for 522 yds. These tms only have 1 SBC foe in common, Ark St & SMiss won 20-19 and were +59 yds & +2 FD's while LA was +251 yds & +14 FD's. While SMiss is 5-2 ATS TY, LA pulled the outright upset of Marshall 2 wks ago in their last SBC road game.

Utah at WASHINGTON ST - After a huge 43-42 win at home over the Trojans (TE Kincaid 15 rec for 217 yds!) followed by a week off, the Utes head to Pullman to take on a Cougars squad has lost 2 straight P12 gms prior to their bye. Utah is 3-0 SU against the Cougs including a 24-13 (-15) win LY in SLC where they overcame a 13-7 deficit in the 3Q by scoring 17 unanswered pts. They have had some struggles on the road however with just a 2-6 ATS mark as an AF. With WSU on a solid 9-3-1 ATS run against P12 foes, this will be an interesting matchup in the Palouse.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 28TH

East Carolina at BYU - 1st mtg since '17. Tms have split their 2 prvs mtgs, but ECU is 2-0 ATS. The Pirates are off a 34-13 (+5) home upset win over UCF, in which they led 17-3 at HT with a 274-206 ydg edge. The win moved ECU to 5-3 SU/ATS & they still remain in the hunt in the AAC. They come in avg 84 more yds than their opps allow (#2), but are all'g 7 more yds than opps gain (#70). BYU lost at

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Liberty 41-14 (-7) to move to 4-4 & is on a 0-6 ATS run. BYU led 14-3 at the end of 1Q, but were shut out the rest of the way as were outg'd 547-248. The Def has all'd 562 ypg & 40 ppg their L/3, while the Off has failed to hit 300 tti yds in 2 of L/3. ECU is off 4-1 ATS as an AD the L2Y, but hasn't traveled this far west since their last trip here in 2015 & BYU certainly has an edge with the altitude in Provo.

Louisiana Tech at FIU - LT is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS in this series and they last met in '19. FIU put up a sn high 453 yards last week and beat Charlotte 34-15 (+14). The Panthers scored the first 34 pts. LT lost starting QB McNeil early then bkp Matthew Downing was hurt late but true frosh Lance Lyddy threw two td's. The Bulldogs lost 42-41 but still covered as +2' despite getting outgained 487-373. LT's D is allowing 490 ypg and 133 ypg more than their foes avg (#130 in FBS). FIU is -88 ypg but LT is -99 though the Bulldogs have played a much tougher sked (#61 vs #131). FIU is 1-5-1 as a home dog but they have won 3 of their last 4 when hosting CUSA West foes.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 29TH

Illinois by 10 over NEBRASKA - ILL has won the last 2 & have covered 3 str in the series. Last year, the Illini pulled a 30-22 (+7) upset at home, despite being outg'd 392-326. Both tms come into this one off a bye. ILL is 6-1 (5-2 ATS) & is on 5 gm win streak & is ranked (#17) for the 1st time since 2011, led by a suffocating Def that ranks #1 in the nation in both scoring & total D all'g just 8.9 ppg & 221 ypg. Offensively, they use a punishing ground attack to control the clock (#6 in TOP), behind RB Brown who has rushed for 1059 (5.5 ypc). NEB sits at 3-4 (2-5 ATS) & has won 2 of L/3 to get back in the bowl conversation, but they did allow 608 yds to PUR in a 43-37 (+14) in a loss 2 wks ago. WR Palmer caught 7 passes for 237 yds (33.9) & 2TDs in the loss and now leads the NCAA with 781 rec yds. The Illini have not been a B10 road fav since 2018, but NEB is just 1-3 ATS at home TY & has lost 19 straight to ranked tms, so we'll gladly lay the points in this one.

Boston College by 3 over CONNECTICUT - BC is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS in this series. UConn is fresh off a bye and has been much more competitive lately, covering 3 straight including a home upset over Fresno St as 23 pt dogs. Prior to their bye they were +9' at Ball St and led 21-10 w/a 270-182 yd edge at half but lost 25-21. BC is now 1-6 ATS on the ssn after losing 43-15 at WF (+20). The Eagles are now missing 4 starters from their rebuilt Oline. They avg just 68 rush ypg (2.3) including only 111 (3.4) vs FCS Maine. UConn avg just 290 ypg but have been better in their L/3, putting up 346 ypg. BC is -179 ypg on the road while UConn is +22 at home. UConn has covered 4 straight and is steadily improving under Jim Mora Jr. We can't imagine backing this struggling Eagles team as a road favorite and think the Huskies keep it closer than expected.

Coastal Carolina by 1 over MARSHALL - First mtg. CC comes into this gm off a bye while MU was on the road at JMU last wk & won 26-12 (JMU QG DNP). MU's DEF is holding tms to 284 ypg, but that number is propped up a bit by holding 2 FCS tms to under 200 yds. Against 5 FBS foes MU is all'g 347 ypg, which is still solid. CC comes in with effective offense that is avg'g 458 ypg & QB McCall is hitting 71% & has an 18-1 ratio! MU's pass D ranks #11 but all'd 300+ pass yds to BG and Troy. MU's offense has largely been RB Laborn (1002, 5.3, 12 td) as their pass offense is avg'g just 140 ypg the L/4 wks & are playing both Colombi & Fancher at QB. Against SBC foes MU is only avg'g 259 ypg/15 ppg. While these tms don't have any common SBC foes, they do have a common foe in FCS Gardner-Webb. MU won that game 28-7 & outgained GW by 278 yds while CC only won 31-27 and were outgained by GW by 141 yds. MU is just 2-7 ATS as a HF under HC Huff while CC is 8-2-1 ATS as an AD under HC Chadwell & we'll call for the stronger offense to emerge victorious by a point.

New Mexico St by 5 over MASSACHUSETTS - New Mexico St won the only prior mtg in LY's ssn finale 44-27 as a 6' pt HF. LY Aggies finished with a 30-16 fd & 623-405 yd edges but both teams are under first year HC's. UMass is off a bye & NMST had LW's game postponed due to a San Jose St player being killed in a traffic incident the day prior to the game. Both are 2-1 ATS their L/3 but while UMass is 0-3 SU in those gms, NMST is 2-1 beating Hawaii 45-26 as a 4' pt HF & New Mexico 21-9 as a 7 pt HD. While flying 2,000 miles to East Coast, game is in late afternoon, so NMST won't feel like they playing a morning game but this is their first time away from home in 6 wks. Aggies have very slight edges on both Off (#124-#130) & Def (#122-#126) but should have a bit more confidence as UMass' only SU win is over an FCS foe. While we will lean with the Aggies, we don't trust them too much against a desperate UMass team.

Miami, Oh by 12 over AKRON - Miami has won a series best 5 straight & visitor has covered 4 straight. LY Akron trailed 34-7 into 4Q as a 20' pt AD but scored final 14 incl the backdoor cover td w/ 31 left. Zips are off a loss to rival KSU, which was starting a True frosh QB (starter warmed up but was inj'd & DNP). They led 10-0 but trailed 33-24 before a FG w/ 39 left but was offside on the outside attempt. LW despite the return of starting QB Gabbert, who missed the prior 6 gms, Miami fell to WM 16-10 as a 6 pt HF. While Gabbert had 222 pass & 24 rush (1 td) he hit just 21-38 & was sacked 7 times. Akron QB Irons threw for 383 LW but with a 1-2 ratio & was also sacked 7 times. The Zips in fact are last in the FBS allowing 43 sacks (13 more than 2nd worse & 20 more than Miami), while Miami's defense has 10 sks the last 3 gms. Akron is still looking for their first FBS win & at 1-7 can not make a bowl but while Miami is all but out of the MAC East race, they can still make a bowl. Miami has a huge Def edge (#55-#120) and with Gabbert knocking the rust off LW, we look for the RedHawks to get their offense in gear vs the Zip's weak Def.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 3 over Missouri - SC is 0-3 SU/ATS in this series. LY SC was only down 3 at half but it was 31-14 MO 4Q and SC went 80/9 & 14/3 for td's to lose 31-28. SC led A&M 17-0 6 minutes in last week with just 19 yards of offense. They had a 100 yd KR td and a 19 yd td drive. SC outgained 398-286 and were out FD'd 23-13 but held on to win 30-24 (+3). QB Rattler completed just under 50% and only has a 5-8 ratio. He faces a MO D that is allowing just 324 ypg and is holding foes 98 ypg below their avg (#12 in FBS). MO led 17-0 at half last week vs Vandy but allowed a fumble ret td and an 80 yd td pass late 4Q to only win 17-14. The Tigers were also -3 TO's. SC is holding foes to 361 ypg and 35 ypg below their avg. MO has had their last 6 games go Under the total and we think the D keeps them close in this game but SC wins thanks to a huge ST's edge.

TENNESSEE by 17 over Kentucky - Tenn is 3-4 SU in this series and is on a 23-7 ATS series run. KY actually won LTH 34-7 when the Vols threw two pick-6's on B2B possessions and were down 17-7 at half despite 203-75 yd edge. KY hasn't won B2B trips to Knoxville since '62-'64. Tenn had absolutely no letdown last week off their win over Bama. They only played FCS UT Martin but still led 52-7 at half, put up 696 yds and won 65-24 (-38). The 'Cats are fresh off a bye and played their best game the week prior, beating Miss St 27-17 and finished w/a 478-225 yd edge. RB Rodriguez ran for a ssn high 197 vs Miss St but he faces a Tenn D that allows just 91 (2.9) rush ypg. The 'Cats Oline has allowed 26 sks. KY will try to employ similar gameplan as last year when they ran 99 plays (just 42 for Tenn) and had a 612-461 yd edge but lost 45-42 thanks to two long passes and a pick 6. KY has covered 4 straight as away dogs but we were surprised this opened under 2 td's and the 'Cats don't have the offense to keep up with Tennessee.

Tcu by 4 over WEST VIRGINIA - As B12 foes TCU won 4 of the F/6 mtgs SU but have lost the L/4 SU incl an outright upset by WVU last ssn in Fort Worth. WVU has also covered 8 of the 10 mtgs as B12 foes. TCU is off a 38-28 win vs KSt where they trailed 28-17 HT but outgained KSt 229-87 2H. WVU lost LW 48-10 at Tex Tech where they were -312 yds and -4 TO's. TCU's offense is rolling this season as they are avg'g 522 ypg/45 ppg and QB Duggan has thrown for 1,871 yds (69%, 19-1) and takes on a WVU pass DEF that ranks #112 & they have all'd 300+ pass yds the their L/3 B12 games. WVU's offense is led by QB Daniels (1686, 64%, 10-6) and WVU avg's 275 pass ypg vs B12 tms, but here take on a TCU pass D ranked #28 as they hold tms to 53% comp. These tms have 1 common B12 foe in common (KU) and WVU was +82 yds (-2 TO) and lost 55-42 in OT (int ret'd for td in OT by KU) while TCU was -88 yds (all'd 540 yds) but won 38-31. WVU has owned this series & this looks like a flat spot for TCU so we'll call for them to keep this game within the line.

FLORIDA ST by 24 over Georgia Tech - GT has won the L/2 mtgs and is 7-0 ATS in this series but they've only met once since 2015. FSU has lost 3 straight since starting 4-0 this ssn. The 'Noles are still +133 ypg and +83 ypg in ACC play while GT is -79 ypg and -73 ypg vs ACC foes. GT had their 2 game win streak broken last Thu when they lost at home to UVA 16-9 (-3) and were outgained 411-202. QB Sims left the game with an injury and bkp Zach Gibson was just 10-25 for 99 yds. FSU's Dline needed their bye to get healthy. They have 18 sacks this year and the D is holding foes 44 ypg below their avg. FSU has a huge edge on offense, avg 465 ypg and 99 ypg more than their foes allow on avg (#16 in FBS). GT avg just 313 ypg and are behind held 53 ypg below what their foes allow (#110 in FBS). FSU is an angry team coming off their bye after close losses to NCSt & Clem and GT just lost their momentum so we think this is a blowout.

Ohio St by 14 over PENN ST - Ohio St has won 9 of the L/10, but Penn St has covered 5 of the L/6, incl LY in Columbus as the Nittany Lions lost 33-24 (+19) & held the Buckeyes to 466 tll yds, 95 yds below their ssn avg. PSU was dominated by Mich 2 wks ago, but did rebound with 45-17 (-4) home win over Minn in their "Whiteout" game LW, which moved them to 6-1 (4-3 ATS). After all'g 418 rush yds to the Wolverines, the Lions held the Gophers (who came in avg'g 228) to 165 yds (3.6 ypc). Their Off, which had struggled the last 2 wks, amassed 479 tll yds. The Buckeyes are 7-0 (4-3 ATS) on the strength of their 54-10 (-29) home win over Iowa. OSU was held to 360 yds (157 yds under ssn avg), but the Def forced 6 TO's & held Iowa to 158 tll yds. The Buckeyes now possess Top 5 units in both tll Off (#5, 517 ypg) & tll D (#2, 240 ypg). Ohio St has failed to cover in 3 of their L/4 in Happy Valley, so we see this one right near the line.

MICHIGAN by 31 over Michigan St - Both tms are off a bye. The Spartans, know as "Little Brother" in this rivalry, have won 2 straight in the series, incl delivering the Wolverines only reg ssn loss LY in a 37-33 (+4) home win. The Spartans, however, have struggled to replicate LY's overall success, as they enter this one at 3-4 SU/ATS & 1-3 in B10 play. They did secure a 34-28 (+7) home win over WISC their last time out, which ended a 4 gm losing skid. MSU held the Badgers to 283 tll yds, after all'g 528 ypg the prvs 4. MICH comes in at 7-0 (4-3 ATS) & dominated Penn St on both sides of the ball 2 wks ago, in their 41-17 (-7) home win. The Wolverines only led 16-14 at HT, despite 274-83 ydg & 18-1 FD edges, but held the Nittany Lions scoreless the last 28 mins. MICH rushed for 418 yds (7.6 ypc) behind our #1 rated OL & RBs Corum (172, 5.9) & Edwards (177, 10.8). Their Def is now all'g just 12 ppg & 250 ypg. The Wolverines will certainly look to exact some revenge in this one & we expect them to roll to a win by over 4 td's.

Miami, FI by 6 over VIRGINIA - UVA is 4-1 SU/3-1-1 ATS in this series. The last 3 meetings were in Coral Gables. LY UVM was -5' in QB Van Dyke's first career start. The 'Canes had just 119 1H yds and trailed 16-7. Van Dyke led 3 td drives in the 2H but UVM fell short 30-28. UVM had 8 TO's last week in their 45-21 (-9) loss to Duke. QB Van Dyke was inj'd 2Q and bkp QB Garcia threw 2 int's and lost 3 fumbles. The 'Canes gave Duke to drives of 23, 22 and 25 yds along with a pick 6. UVA has a couple days of extra rest after upsetting GTech 16-9 (+3) on the road. UVA had a 411-202 yd edge. QB Armstrong still only has a 6-9 ratio. The 'Canes gave up 6 sacks LW and face a UVA D that has 23 sks including 8 vs GT. UVM is 0-6 ATS on the ssn vs FBS foes yet they are +104 ypg and are +87 ypg vs ACC foes while UVA is +14 ypg and -23 ypg vs ACC foes but the 'Hoos have played a MUCH tougher sked (#43 vs #116). We know there is no way the 'Canes have 8 TO's again and even w/o Van Dyke we don't mind laying points against a poor UVA team.

IOWA by 9 over Northwestern - The home team has lost 4 str in the series & there have been 4 outright upsets in the L/6 yrs, incl a 21-20 (+1) win by NW LTH in 2020. The Wildcats come into this one as losers of 6 str (2-4 ATS) after their 31-24 (+14) loss at MD & have not won since August! NW avg just 17 ppg in their L/6, while also being -8 in TO differential. Iowa was held to just 158 yds in a 54-10 (+29) loss at Ohio St LW, in which they turned the ball over 6 times! They are now avg'g just 14 ppg & 227 ypg, which is last in the NCAA. The Def remains stout, as they come in at #6, holding their opps to 108 yds below their ssn avg. Based on the series history & both teams anemic offenses, we like the Wildcats to keep this one within the line in a low scoring affair.

Old Dominion by 1 over GEORGIA ST - Met 3 times (2010-12) and ODU won all 3 by at least 14 pts. GSt had a mini bye week, playing 10 days ago at App St where they led 14-0 but allowed 404 rush yds (6.3) and were blown out 42-17. LW ODU hosted GStHm and lost 28-23 despite being +46 yds they missed 2 FG's and were SOD twice. ODU's offense the L/2 gms has been much improved, putting up 525 yds & 461 yds & here face a GSt DEF that has all'd 450+ yds in 5 of the L/6 gms & ODU got 324 rush (10.5) yds 2 wks ago and LW threw for 328 yds despite TE Kuntz missing the gm.

GSt does run the ball well (233, 5.1) but ODU held Coastal to 88 rush (2.1) 2 wks ago. ODU also has a superb pass rush (24 sks, 10.0%) and LW against App St the GSt OL all'd 6 sacks. ODU is on a 6-2 ATS run as an underdog and we will call for them to get the outright win.

Pitt by 3 over NORTH CAROLINA - Pitt has won L/2 mtgs SU/ATS but NC won 6 straight from '13-'18. Pitt enters off a misleading 24-10 loss to L'ville where they led 10-7 4Q and were at the UL 40 down 7 when they gave up a fumble ret. RB Abanikanda had another solid effort with 129 yds and is now #4 in the FBS with 959 rush (6.1). NC is fresh off a bye after a fortunate win over Duke on the road. The Heels have allowed 4 foes to top 200 rush including the Blue Devils who had 297 (7.1). Pitt has a HUGE edge on D, holding foes 53 ypg below their avg (#25 in FBS) while NC is allowing foes to put up 107 ypg more than their avg (#126 in FBS). Pitt is also #17 in pass D rankings (53%, 10-6) led by Thorpe candidate, S Hallett (3 int, 6 pbu). NC has 4 close wins this ssn while Pitt essentially has 3 close losses including in OT to Tenn. 3 of the last 4 mtgs have resulted in outright upsets and Narduzzi is 16-8 as an away dog. With everything suggesting a close game, we will lean with the dog.

MINNESOTA by 10 over Rutgers - 1st mtg since 2019. Rutgers comes in at 4-3 (5-2 ATS) & hasn't had a winning record this late in the ssn since '14. They're off a 24-17 (PK) home win over IND, in which they limited the Hoosiers to 272 tll yds, incl just 95 in the 2H. The Knights all'd a 93 yd KOR TD to start the game & an add'l 1Q TD, but then held IND scoreless until under 2 mins left 4Q. The Def is now all'g just 284 ypg, incl 87 rush ypg (2.9) & has held their L/3 opps to at least 80 yds under their ssn avg. MIN ply'd without starting QB Morgan (should return here) in their 45-17 (+5) loss at Penn St & were held to 340 tll yds, while all'g a ssn high 479 yds. The Gophers have lost 3 str after opening 4-0 (4-3 ATS) & have all'd 437 ypg the L/3 after all'g just 188 ypg the 1st 4. Rutgers is 8-2 ATS as an AD since HC Schiano returned in '20, incl 2-0 TY & has the ability to limit the ground game, so we like them to keep this one within the line.

South Alabama by 13 over ARKANSAS ST - SAla is on a 4-1 SU/ATS run vs Ark St incl winning & covering the L/3 mtgs. SAla lost last Thur at home vs rival Troy where they were held to 246 yds and 6 pts while Ark St was w/o QB Blackman LW (check status) and they lost 38-18 to LA (-251 yds, -14 FD's). SAla comes in with a strong DEF that holds foes to 59 ypg under their ssn avg and the L/4 gms Ark St has only avg'd 295 ypg. Ark St has all'd over 500 yds in 4 gms TY and their pass D ranks #116 & here they face a SAla offense led by QB Bradley (1901, 65%, 13-5) and 3 talented WR's in Wayne, Lacy, and Voinis who have all topped 400 yds rec this ssn. Against 2 common foes (ULM, LA) SAla is +130 ypg while Ark St -186 ypg. Overall vs SBC foes SAla is +80 ypg while Ark St is -102. SAla has yet to cover a SBC game this ssn, but with Ark St's offense struggling & possibly w/o their veteran QB facing an angry SAla team with extra time to prep (played last Thur) getting the win by nearly 2 td's.

Arizona St by 3 COLORADO - Battle of interim HC's in this one as the Sun Devils head into Boulder following a 1 pt loss at Stanford (led 14-6 at HT). The Buffs meanwhile moved to 1-1 since the dismissal of Karl Dorrell as the Beavers finished with 26-17 FD and 472-290 yd edges in the 42-9 victory (CU -3 TO's). The Sun Devils lead the all-time series 9-3 including a 35-13 (-14) victory LY in Tempe where they finished with 25-18 FD and 439-250 yd edges. They have however struggled as an AF dating back to '18 with just a 2-7 ATS mark (0-3 ATS LY incl 2 SU losses). While we'll go ahead and give ASU the outright win in this one, we're cutting off our lean at just a FG with the home team going 9-3 ATS in the series and the Buffs winning 4 of the L/5 on Homecoming.

BOISE ST by 34 over Colorado St - As MW foes Boise St is a perfect 11-0 SU and 8-3 ATS vs CSU. Boise St is off a 19-14 win at AF that delivered an outright upset winner for our Underdog POW while CSU hosted Hawaii & got their 2nd win of the ssn & broke 300 yds on offense for the 1st time this ssn. Despite the switch to the 'Air Raid' the Rams offense is only avg'g 267 ypg/13 ppg. Here the Rams face a Boise DEF that is holding teams to 115 ypg under their ssn avg (#6 FBS). Boise's pass rush has 15 sks the L/6 gms and they face a CSU OL that has allowed 29 sks (15.6%). Boise's offense has looked much better since QB Green took over as they are avg'g 405 ypg/31 ppg however their run gm struggled LW (115, 2.9) with RB Holani out (check status). CSU has allowed 380 ypg but have faced just the #97 schedule & face a BSU team that has beaten SDSU and Fresno at home already TY by 20+ pts each & were a comb'd +546 yds in those gms. BSU is also 3-0-1 ATS TY vs MW foes & we see the Broncos winning by nearly 5 td's.

RICE by 17 over Charlotte - Rice is 2-1 SU/ATS in this series but CLT did win last year 31-24 in OT (-6) despite getting outgained 468-349. The 49ers fired HC Will Healy after their 34-15 home loss to FIU. Rice mathed their ssn high yds last week with 487 and pulled out a 42-41 (-2) win at LA Tech. The Owls were +114 yds but trailed 10-0 1Q and had to overcome 3 TO's. QB McMahon had a 3-0 ratio and WR McCaffrey had 171 yds and 2 td's. CLT has the worst pass D in the country, allowing 281 ypg (73%, 18-5). McMahon had covered every game as a starter up until last week (5-1 ATS) while CLT is 2-6 ATS and both covers came as 20+ point dogs. A win here puts Rice 1 win away from Bloomgren's first bowl so they won't have pity on a poor opponent.

Usc by 10 over ARIZONA - After a narrow 43-42 defeat in SLC against the Utes where QB Williams threw for 381 yds and 5 TD's, an angry one-loss Trojans squad heads into the desert well-rested following a bye week. The Wildcats meanwhile are also returning from a bye with a 49-39 shootout loss in Seattle (QB de Laura 400 pass yds & 4 TD's) happening the week prior. USC has picked up victories in 18 of the L/20 against the Wildcats including 9 straight (longest streak in series history). LY Arizona (trailed 35-14 at HT) trimmed their deficit to 7 with 1:26 left before a failed side game gave the Trojans (-21) the 41-34 victory. While the Trojans are on a 7-2 ATS run as an AF coming in, laying too many points could be dangerous against a confident Arizona team that's lost by just 7 and 4 the past 2 years.

LOUISVILLE (+5') over Wake Forest

LOUISVILLE over Wake Forest - L'ville is 3-0 ATS in this series. This game has also gone over in 6 straight (avg 81.5 ppg!). The Deacons are already bowl eligible after beating BC 43-15 (-20'). QB Hartman had 6 total TD's and has a 21-3 ratio. UL got QB Cunningham back last week vs Pitt but they trailed 10-7 4Q. The Cardinals only had 312 yds and were +3 TO's and a late 59 yd fumble ret'd gave UL a misleading 14 point win (+1). UL is +61 ypg while WF is +63 and the Cardinals have played a much tougher sked (#16 vs #74). UL has the edge on D, holding foes 55 ypg below their avg and they have 24 sacks (12.1%) led by DE Yaya Diaby (5.5 sk). WF is allowing foes to put up 3 ypg above their avg. Cunningham did leave the game briefly last week but returned and he should be fully healthy for this one. Series history suggests a shootout but we like UL's defense to be the winning edge

FRESNO ST by 10 over San Diego St - Since 2012 Fresno is 6-3 SU/5-3-1 ATS vs SDSt. Fresno St is off B2B MW wins after they blew out NMex last week 41-9 (+372 yds, +20 FD's!) while SDSt got a 23-7 win over Nevada (+90 yds) with newly named starter Jalen Mayden leading the way & SDSt held Nev to 227 total yds. Big game for the MW West Division as both teams are very much alive for the MW title game & a win here would go a long way. Fresno has been looking better every week with QB Fife under center and QB Haener has been practicing some (status?) but Fresno did run for 285 yds (5.7) LW as well and earlier TY SDSt did allow Boise to rush for 316 (7.2). Fresno's pass rush has also delivered 10 sks the L/3 games while SDSt have given up multiple sacks the L/3 games. For the season Fresno is +39 ypg while SDSt -81 ypg despite facing the easier schedule (#91 vs #114). SDSt is also -36 FD's this season while Fresno is +2 FD's. We like the way Fresno has played the L/2 wks and will side with them by DD's.

UCLA by 17 over Stanford - Following wins against the Irish (2 pt win as 16' pt dog) and Sun Devils where they were held to just 5 FG's in a 15-14 win, the Cardinal head South to take on a Bruins team that suffered their 1st loss of the ssn LW in Eugene with the Ducks jumping out to a 31-13 HT lead in the eventual 45-30 victory (UCLA outgained 545-448). While UCLA leads the all-time series (47-43-3), they have struggled recently losing 12 of the L/14. LY's matchup did see the Bruins (-4) pick up a 35-24 win in Palo Alto with DTR throwing a pair of 4Q TD's (455-360 yd edge). With UCLA on a 9-4 ATS run coming in against P12 foes and the Cardinal still a porous 2-12 ATS dating back to the middle of LY, we expect the Bruins to get back on track here (Stanford 1-10 ATS run in conf play).

Oregon by 13 over CALIFORNIA - The Ducks head to Berkeley off of a huge victory over former HC Chip Kelly and the Bruins with QB Nix throwing for 283 yds and 5 TD's (UO 545-448 yd edge). The Bears meanwhile dropped a close home matchup against the Huskies with QB Plummer throwing for 245 yds and 3 TD's (UW 28-18 FD & 476-306 yd edges). Oregon has won 11 of the L/13 against the Bears including a 24-17 (-13') victory LY in Autzen where they needed a late SOD by their defense to hold on. While the Bears a solid 9-3 as a HD coming in, the Ducks have outscored their past 6 opponents (5-1 ATS) by 23 ppg and show no signs of slowing down.

HOUSTON by 17 over Usf - HOU has won 6 straight in series & has covered 4 of the L/5, but USF did cover LY in a 54-42 (+13') loss, despite being out'd 646-399. USF comes into this mtg off a bye, but lost starting QB Bohannon for the ssn in their 45-31 (+12) home loss to Tulane 2 wks ago. SO Marsh replaced Bohannon & threw for 150 yds (7-15) & TD's & will be making his 3rd career start here. The 1-6 Bulls have lost 5 in a row, are 2-5 ATS & have yet to beat an FBS tm this yr. HOU is off a 38-20 (-3) road win over Navy, in which they held Navy's option attack to 201 yds (4.0), 47 yds below their ssn avg. HOU Off has been crisper the L/2 wks, as they've avg'd 35 ppg & 452 ypg. HOU is just 2-5-1 as a DD HF under Holgerson & USF is 2-1 ATS as an AD TY, but we don't have a strong lean here.

TULSA by 3 over Smu - Tulsa has covered 5 str in series, incl 2 outright upsets. TUL won 27-16 (-13') at Temple LW, to move to 3-4 SU/ATS. TUL out'd the Owls 454-280, behind 231 rush yds (11.6) from RB Prince. The OL continued to struggle in pass pro, as they all'd 7 sks & have now all'd 20 sks the L3W. SMU is off a 29-27 (+3') home loss to CIN. SMU was held to a ssn low 259 yds, but stayed in the game by forcing FGs & actually had a 2pt chance to tie with 2 mins left. They have lost 4 of their L/5 & are just 2-5 ATS. They are avg'g 34 ppg & 457 ypg, but they have been unable to stop the run, all'g 205 rush ypg. SMU has not won in Tulsa since '09 (0-5 SU) & the Hurricane are 5-1 ATS as a HD since 2018, so we'll side with the home team that got their run game on track last week.

Oklahoma St by 4 over KANSAS ST - Both teams are off facing ranked B12 foes LW with OSU came back from a 10-pt 3Q deficit to win 41-34 vs Texas as OSU forced 3 int's & QB Sanders bounced back throwing for 391 yds! OSU also had 0 penalties while Texas had 14 for 119 yds! This season OSU is tied with Navy as being the least penalized team in the FBS. KSt looked to be in control at TCU at HT leading 28-17 but were held to 87 2H yds as both starting QB Martinez (left 1Q) and bkp QB Howard (left 3Q) left the gm with inj's and 3rd string QB Rubley threw just 1 pass & it was an INT. Howard did come back in the 2H but he was clearly less than 100%. Neither team is playing well on DEF in B12 play as OSU is all'g 504 ypg while KSt is all'g 449 ypg. However, OSU is 8-3-1 ATS since 2020 against ranked teams and are on a 7-1 ATS run s/18 as an away dog in Big 12 regular & they are a slight dog as of presstime. We'll back OSU here who is on a 13-1 ATS run in Big 12 regular season games and KSt could be playing this game without their top 2 QB's this week (check status).

Baylor by 3 over TEXAS TECH - BU has won 3 of the L/4 mtgs SU but are just 1-3 ATS and the L/3 gms have been decided by 3 pts or less. Last week BU led KU 28-3 HT (249-58 yd edge, +14 FD's) but needed a late 4Q TD to get the cover (won 35-23). TT led 17-3 at HT over WVU but TT outscored WVU 31-7 2H for a 8-10 win (+312 yds, +4 TO). While BU has been great against the run (108, 3.3) their pass DEF has allowed 253 ypg vs B12 foes and TT comes into this game with the #3 pass offense in the FBS, avg'g 364 ypg overall incl 356 ypg vs B12 foes. Despite whispers of QB Shough coming back LW, TT QB Morton got the start & threw for 325 yds. At home TT is +207 ypg/+24 ppg and 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS incl an upset of Texas. However we'll side with BU as they played much better than the score indicated LW (+149 yds/+17 FD's) and just need to win the game to get the cover & think their DEF (holding foes to 51 ypg under ssn avg, #56 pass D) can slow TT down.

TEXAS A&M by 3 over Ole Miss - A&M is out for revenge after losing LY as 2' pt chawk, 29-19. The Aggies were shutout in the 1H and were outgained 408-91 but only trailed 15-0. The Aggies fell victim to the curse of the Power Sweep 4* last week as they allowed a KR td, then after two TO's deep in their own territory were down 17-0 despite SCar having just 19 yards offense. A&M got within 24-21 but of course starting QB Haynes King was inj'd and the Aggies lost 30-24 (-3). Ole Miss was 7-0 but still the underdog at LSU. The Rebels led 20-17 at half but were shutout for the 2nd time this ssn in the 2H (also vs Tulsa) and lost 45-20. The Rebels allowed a ssn high 500 yds as their rush D was gashed for the 2nd straight game, allowing 301 vs Aub and 252 vs LSU. Ole Miss is +125 ypg while A&M is -11 ypg but the Aggies have ply'd a much tougher sked (#7 vs #64) and A&M will be fired up for their first home game in more than a month!

Arkansas by 8 over AUBURN - Ark is 0-6 SU/1-5 ATS in series but LTH was their closest call, when the Hogs led 28-27 4Q and Aub spiked the ball backwards but it was ruled int'l grounding and the Tigers kicked a GW fg. Aub is on a 3 game losing streak but did lead LSU 17-0 2Q and only lost at Ole

Miss by 14. Both tms enter off a bye. Prior to their week off, Ark put up a ssn high 644 yds and won at BYU 52-35 (PK). Aub has the edge on D, holding foes 31 ypg below their avg but they've given up 500 & 578 in their L/2 and Ole Miss rushed for 448 yds on them. Ark's strength is the run game behind Raheim 'Rocket' Sanders who has 870 (6.2) and they avg 240 (5.0) rush ypg. Ark's D is allowing 457 ypg and 67 ypg more than their foes avg but their run D only allows 143 ypg (4.3) while their pass D has struggled, allowing 314 ypg. Aub QB Ashford only has a 4-5 ratio. This will be just the 2nd time under Pittman that Ark is a road fav so we will treat lightly and call for the Hogs to win by just over a td.

NAVY by 21 over Temple - Navy has won & covered the L/2, incl a 38-14 (+12.5) road win LY. The Middies come in off a 38-20 (+3) home loss vs HOU LW, in which they were out'd 441-326 & held to 201 rush yds, after avg'g 414 the prvs 2 wks. The Navy Def has all'd 441 yds in B2B wks, after all'g 345 the prvs 3, but are still holding opps to 37 yds below their ssn avg (#47). Temple is 2-5 (4-3 ATS) & has lost 3 str, after a 27-16 (+13') home loss to Tulsa, in which they were out'd 454-280. The Def produced a pick 6 & had 7 sks to keep the Owls in the gm, but also all'd 299 rush yds (6.5). The Temple Off is only avg'g 283 ypg & has been held under 300 in 5 of their 7 gms. Temple is 0-3 ATS on the road & has struggled to stop the run, so we'll side with the home tm as they control this one on the ground.

WKU by 11 over North Texas - WKU is 4-0 SU in this series but they haven't met since 2016. The 'Toppers had a ssn low 20 pts and 352 yds last week at home vs UAB yet won by a fg. QB Reed threw for a ssn low 128 yds but UAB lost their st'g QB to inj and threw for just 96 yds themselves. NT led UTSA 27-24 last week but gave up the GW td with :15 left. The Mean Green were outgained 495-347 and out FD'd 32-13. NT allows 283 pass ypg and 2 weeks ago allowed LA Tech to throw for 424. The Mean Green D is allowing 472 ypg and foes put up 70 ypg more than their avg. WKU allows 135 (3.6) rush and NT rushes for 223 (5.5) but was held to just 22 rush last week. This is a tough 2nd straight road game for NT and we think WKU's offense gets back on track and wins by double digits.

Georgia by 16 over Florida - Jacksonville. UGA has won 4 of L/5 mtgs in what has turned into a blowout fest. Only 1 of the last 8 mtgs have been decided by less than 2 td's with the avg MOV 20 ppg. Both tms are fresh off a bye. UGA seems to have gotten over their early ssn boredom after beating Aub by 32 & Vandy by 55. FL already has 3 losses in Napier's first year but none by over 10 pts. The Gators home loss to LSU also looks much better after they smoked Ole Miss last week. LY was QB Richardson's first start and UGA had 3 td's off 3 turnovers in 12 plays to blow open a close game that UGA ended up winning 34-7. It's hard to go against UGA but Napier is 9-3-1 as an away dog and they will use their strong run game (213, 6.4) to eat clock and keep this closer than expected.

Wyoming by 8 over HAWAII - 2022 continues to be a struggle for Hawas they are -115 ypg in the season and their D is allowing foes to gain 106 ypg above their ssn avg (#129). As for WY, HC Bohl is doing a masterful job, as WY is in the hunt for the MW title and are 1 win away from bowl elig & they came into TY #129 in exp. Last wk WY won 28-14 over a USU tm starting a 4th string QB and they held them to 217 total yds while gaining 529 yds including 330 rush yds (6.6). UH's run DEF struggles as they allow 212 ypg/5.8 ypc. Haw's wins TY are over a depleted Nev team & an FCS tm where they were outgained by 180 yds. LW they lost to a struggling Colo St team 17-13. WY is holding MW foes to 316 ypg/19 ppg and while we see the Cowboys coming away with the win, UH is just 3-5 ATS as a DD away favorite vs MW foes, so we'll cut our lean off at just over a td.

Uab by 3 over FAU - UAB has won 2 of the last 3 meetings but the LTH was the CUSA Title game and Kiffin's Owls won 49-6 (-8). UAB lost QB Hopkins to inj and RB McBride fumbled twice last week in their 20-17 (+1) loss at WKU. FAU was outgained 412-329 last week but got a pick 6 and only lost 24-21 at UTEP (-4). The Owls are 3-5 and a bowl bid will mean having to upset either UAB or WKU at home. UAB just held WKU's vaunted pass attack to ssn lows of 352 yds and 128 passing. The Blazers avg 242 rush ypg (5.8) while FAU has allowed over 230 rush yds in 3 of their last 5. The Blazers have the edge in all 3 phases but FAU is much better at home where they are 11-3 SU and UAB is 0-3 SU/ATS on the road this year so we give the Owls a slight lean.

UTEP by 6 over Middle Tennessee - MT has won 3 of the 4 meetings and are 3-0-1 ATS but they haven't met since '18. UTEP trailed 14-6 last week thanks to Hardison's pick 6 in the 3Q but they pulled through and won 24-21 on Baeche's fg with no time remaining. UTEP had a 412-329 yd edge. RB Hankins had 138 yds. MT is fresh off a bye but they've lost 3 straight, all by double-digits. In fact, the only shine on MT's resume at this point is their win at Miami which was highlighted by 3 long passes. UTEP has a solid pass D, allowing 54% and 194 ypg. MT has played 3 of the best teams in CUSA, losing by 20 ppg. MT is -66 ypg while UTEP is +12 vs similar sked strengths. The Miners D is holding foes 25 ypg below their avg. After just a 1-3 start, UTEP has won 3 of their L/4 and could close strong with a soft schedule the next 2 weeks. We like UTEP's strong ST of their edge to be the diff and have them winning by a fg but it could be even more with MT's propensity for blowouts.

TUESDAY NOVEMBER 1ST

Buffalo at OHIO - The kickoff of Weekday MACtion football is a showdown for the lead in the MAC East as Buffalo comes in 4-0 in conf play while Ohio is 3-1 and the winner will have that big head-to-head tiebreaker. The HT is 10-1 SU & 9-2 ATS, while Ohio is just 10-7 SU & 9-8 ATS vs Buffalo. LY Ohio led 21-0 2Q & 26-10 mid 4Q as a 7 pt AD but allowed final 17 incl GW fg as time expired. LW Buffalo trailed Toledo 27-10 into 4Q but scored 24 unanswered for the 34-27 outright upset as a 7 pt HD, giving us 1 of our 3 winning Marquee plays last Saturday. Ohio has covered 4 straight incl an outright 24-17 upset of LY's MAC champ NIU as a 3 pt HD. Buffalo is 7-1 ATS covering 6 straight with 5 straight wins. Will it be the Bulls or the Bobcats who keep their streak going.

Ball St at KENT ST - HT has won 7 straight (5-2 ATS) & KSU is 3-2 SU & ATS incl a 41-38 win as a 3' pf HD in their last mtg '19). Both are 2-2 in MAC & a loss will all but knock them out of their division races. Ball St is 4-2 SU & 3-5 ATS while Kent St is just 3-5 SU & ATS but KSU has played a much tougher schedule (#56-#118). LW KSU's starting QB Schlee was a late scratch (check status) but true frosh QB Kargman led the come from behind 33-27 win over rival Akron but failed to cover as a 16 pt HF. Ball St led EM 16-10 into 4Q as a 2' pt HF but allowed 10 unanswered. One of these MAC matchups will be our Tues Nite Marquee, get it for just \$12 after Noon EST.

They now welcome a Cardinals team that's on extra rest of their own after hosting the Saints last Thur (outgained 494-326, +3 TO's incl 2 IR TD's). In their Wk 2 matchup a year ago, the Cardinals (-3) got 400 pass yds and 4 ttl TD's from Kyler Murray in the narrow 34-33 victory. With MIN going 4-13-1 ATS as home chalk coming in and failing to cover 9 of their past 12 off a bye, we give the Cardinals a chance to grab the upset here as they've won 8 straight as an AD outright. **FORECAST: Arizona by 8**

3★ Ny Giants over SEATTLE - After yet another upset win LW in JAX to move to 6-1 on the ssn (3★ Newsletter Winner!), the surprising Giants head to the Pacific NW to take on a SEA squad that picked up a road upset of their own LW against the Chargers (3★ LP Winner!) with rookie RB Walker rushing for 168 yds and 2 TD's. Following a 4-gm losing skid to the Seahawks from '11-'17 where they were outscored by 18 ppg, the Giants (+11) picked up a surprising 17-12 upset win at SEA in '20 despite 21-13 FD and 327-290 yd deficits. While SEA has gone a solid 6-3 ATS in recent home matchups, we find it hard to go against the Giants right now as they've covered 6 of their past 7 overall and 22 of the past 32 as an AD. **FORECAST: Ny Giants by 6**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ NY JETS over New England - It's a pretty exciting time to be a NY sports fan at the moment as the Yankees were in the ALCS after taking out our beloved Guardians while the Giants and Jets are both sitting on winning records so far in '22. The Jets moved to a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS on the road LW against the Broncos despite 21-10 FD and 324-260 yd deficits. The Patriots meanwhile are back in action on short rest after hosting the Bears on MNF. The Patriots have dominated this series with 12 consecutive wins (8-4 ATS, 20 pt avg MOV) including a 25-6 (-6) here a year ago with Jets rookie QB Zach Wilson forced into 4 int's. While NE is also on an 11-5-1 ATS run as of presstime, we're drinking the green Kool Aid at the moment as the Jets have covered 5 of their L/6 overall (7-3 ATS run as a dog). **FORECAST: NY JETS by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

Baltimore at TAMPA BAY - Thursday - After a handful of less than desirable matchups in recent weeks, Amazon Prime FINALLY gets a contest worth talking about as Lamar Jackson and the Ravens (narrow 3 pt win over CLE LW, outgained 336-254) head South to take on Tom Brady and the Bucs who were held to just 3 pts in their 2nd consecutive upset loss LW in Charlotte (TB has lost outright as 9' & 13 pt favorites). Since '06, the Ravens have won all 4 meetings (2-0-2ATS) against the Bucs with an 18 pt avg MOV. Brady (TB 9-2-1 ATS as HD) and company should be laser focused here however after losing 2 of their 3 HG's on the ssn (0-3 ATS). **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

↑ Jacksonville by 1 over Denver - London. This marks the 2nd trip across the pond for the Broncos (24-16 loss to SF in '10) following a 7 pt home loss to the Jets where bkp QB Rypien (24-46-225-0-1) started in place of the inj'd Russell Wilson. The Jaguars meanwhile have been a mainstay in London with 8 all-time trips including a 23-20 comeback win over MIA a year ago where they connected on a 53-yd FG as time expired. JAX fell just short of a comeback attempt (stopped at 1 on final play of regulation) LW at home against the Giants (3★ Newsletter Winner on NYG!). These 2 met a year ago with DEN (-6) picking up a 23-13 win (22-12 FD & 398-189 yd edge). While DEN's offense continues to disappoint and Wilson is once again a question mark here, JAX has failed to cover 12 of their past 15 overall and will likely struggle against a Broncos defense that's allowing just 16 ppg (#3 NFL) and 286 ypg (#2 NFL) on the year.

DALLAS by 13 over Chicago - Following an 18 pt home win LW against the Lions where Dak Prescott went 19-25 for 207 yds (1 TD) in his return from injury, the Cowboys are back in Arlington for a 2nd straight week to take on a Bears squad on short rest after a MNF trip to Foxboro. In their last meeting back in '19, the Bears (+3) picked up a 31-24 upset inside of Soldier Field. Despite that victory, CHI has failed to cover 5 of the past 7 away from home as of presstime while DAL is 7-3 ATS as a HF and starting to get healthier.

NEW ORLEANS by 6 over Las Vegas - The Raiders had a successful return from bye a week ago at home against the Texans with 3 late TD's in a 38-20 win (RB Jacobs 143 rush yds & 3 TD). They now head into the Superdome to take on a Saints squad with extra rest following an 8 pt road loss in the desert against the Cardinals (ARZ 2 IR TD's, Saints 494-326 yd edge). The Saints have dropped 2 straight in this series including a '20 trip to Vegas where the Raiders (+6) opened up their new stadium with a 34-24 upset victory. While they have also gone just 2-6 ATS in NDIV HG's, backing the Raiders is a little bit risky considering that they've failed to cover 21 of their past 30 against the NFC.

ATLANTA by 9 over Carolina - The Falcons saw their 6-0 ATS streak snapped LW on the road against the Bengals who had 29-13 FD and 537-214 yd edges in a 35-17 victory. They now welcome a Panthers squad that was trending in the opposite direction as far as the spread was concerned heading into LW before a shocking 21-3 (+13) home win over the Bucs where we picked up a 3★ LP Winner on Under 39.5! The visitor in this series has won 4 in a row SU and ATS (all as dogs) including a 19-13 win by the Panthers (+3) here a year ago. While ATL is also just 1-6 ATS as a HF, the Panthers have failed to cover 6 of their L/8 as an AD while also going 7-13 ATS inside of the DIV.

PHILADELPHIA by 14 over Pittsburgh - The Battle of Pennsylvania has seen the home team dominate dating back to '04 with a 15 pt avg MOV. In their Heinz Field meeting in '20, the Steelers (-7) picked up a 38-29 win with Big Ben throwing for 239 yds and 3 TD's. PIT had their share of offensive struggles LW in South Beach with QB Pickett tossing 3 int's (Steelers held scoreless in 2H). The Eagles meanwhile are well-rested following their bye week and boasting the only undefeated record in the NFL. With PHI covering 4 of their L/5 coming in and the Steelers going just 1-7 ATS against the NFC, we're expecting the recent home trend in this series to continue.

Miami by 7 over DETROIT - The Dolphins got back into the win column LW in the return of Tua under center as MIA allowed just 10 pts in a 6 pt victory. They now head into Ford Field to take on a Lions squad that struggled LW in DAL in their return from bye (held to just 6 pts in L/2 gms after avg 35 ppg over their 1st 4 contests). After dropping 5 straight from '94-'06, the Lions have come out victorious in 3 consecutive matchups including a 32-21 road win (-3) in '18 where they had 24-19 FD and 457-322 yard edges. While DET is 8-2 ATS as a HD, we expect a much stronger Dolphins team to grab the victory here (MIA has covered 10 of L/16 overall).

HOUSTON by 1 over Tennessee - The Titans picked up the series sweep of DIV rival IND LW in Nashville despite just 254 yds of offense (19-10 victory!). The Texans meanwhile blew a 20-17 lead in the 4Q LW in Las Vegas with the Raiders scoring 21 unanswered in an 18 pt win

(HOU 404-400 yd edge). The Titans have picked up wins in 4 of the L/5 in this series including a 28-25 (-10') Wk 18 win LY in HOU (led 21-0 at HT). They have struggled as an AF however with just 2 covers in their past 8 tries. The 49ers are on the road for the 3rd time in 4 wks following a home meeting against the Chiefs that saw them allow 44 pts and 529 yds in a 21 pt defeat. Other than LY's NFC Championship meeting where the Rams collected a 20-17 win en route to their SB Title, the 49ers have come out victorious in 7 consecutive regular ssn matchups with a 9 pt avg MOV.
