KEY SELECTIONS

4★ KANSAS over Texas Tech - KU has just 1 SU win vs TT since 2004 and that came in 2019 at home. This is also the 1st time KU is the favorite vs TT since 2008. TT is off of a 35-28 win vs TCU despite getting outgained & out TD'ed (+2 TO). KU secured a winning ssn for the first time s/'08 with a 28-21 win at ISU LW. In their 5 losses TY TT is -9 TO's and at home TY KU is +5 TO's. TT run D has improved (132, 3.7 L/4 gms) but KU is avg'g 189 rush (5.2) in B12 play and are led by RB's Neal (828, 6.1) and Hishaw (517, 5.8) plus QB Bean is mobile. TT has also all'd 300+ pass yds in 3 of their L/5 B12 gms. TT comes in 2-7 ATS on the road under HC McGuire while KU is on a 9-1-1 ATS run at home incl going 5-0 ATS this season. We like the Jayhawks here by DD's!

3★ Oklahoma St over UCF - First meeting. Last week UCF got their first B12 win over Cincy 28-26 (-122 yds, +2 TO) while Okla St upset OU at home 27-24 where we got an outright winner on the Underdog POW (4 straight Underdog POW winners!) and a 4★ LP winner! Okla St's offense is catching fire, avg'g 532 ypg/40 ppg the L/4 gms led by RB Gordon (1224, 7.0, 12 td) and UCF's run D is allowing 281 ypg (5.9) the L/4 games. Okla St's D is allowing 451 ypg in B12 play and UCF is putting up 417 ypg in B12 play & are running for 191 (5.2) but Okla St is forcing TO's as they are +7 TO the L/5 gms. Against 5 common B12 foes Okla St is +51 ypg/+13 ppg while UCF is -80 ypg/-11 ppg. Okla St has covered 5 straight while UCF is just 1-3 ATS against the original B12 members. **FORECAST: Oklahoma St by 13**
3★ SAN JOSE ST over Fresno St - SJSt has dropped 4 of the L/5 mtgs SU & the L/6 mtgs have gone 'Under' with an avg of 37 pts. Fresno is currently in line to play for the MW title, but despite winning vs Boise LW were outgained & in MW play are -16 ypg while SJSt is +76 ypg. The L/4 gms Fresno has all'd 452 ypg and SJSt's offense has put up 450 ypg/39 ppg the L/4 gms incl rushing for 208 (5.5). Fresno has the #29 pass D (56%, 14 int's) but SJSt QB Cordeiro has 3 int's all ssn. SJSt's D has stepped up the L/3 gms (284 ypg/15 ppg) and are at home here off the bye, plus have faced the tougher sked (#77 vs #117). SJSt has covered 6 of their L/7 gms while Fresno is just 1-4 ATS in MW play. Two weeks ago we used SJSt as both a 2★ on these pages and a 3★ LPS when they crushed Hawaii 35-0 (-10') and we are going back to the Spartans again this week!

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ OREGON over Usc - After picking up a 63-19 home win LW against Cal with QB Nix finishing with 389 ttl yds and 6 TD's (UO 597-286 yd & 32-16 FD edges), the Ducks are back inside of Autzen to take on a Trojans squad that dropped their 3rd game of the ssn LW at home against undefeated Washington (gave up a ssn-worst 572 yds, easy 3★ LP Total Winner on Over 77!). Oregon has won and covered 4 of the L/5 against USC although the most recent meeting occurred in the '20 P12 Title game (31-24 UO as 3 pt dog). With the outright winner covering 13 straight and the favorite on a 10-3 ATS run, we expect the Ducks to pick up another big win as they've covered 8 of their L/10 as home chalk.

FORECAST: OREGON by 24

2★ Tennessee over MISSOURI - Tennessee is 4-0 SU/ATS in this series, scoring 66 & 62 the L2Y. The Vols come in well rested after beating UConn 59-3 (-35) while Mizzou comes in off a physical affair against UGA. The Tigers did only trail 24-21 4Q but QB Cook was int'd on their L/2 possessions. Tenn led Bama on the road 20-7 at half and won at KY to end a 4 gm "true" road game losing streak. RB Schraeder topped 100 against UGA but the Vols are allowing just 97 rush ypg (2.9) and have 30 sacks TY. Tennessee has the best trio of RB's in the SEC (comb'd 1645, 6.2) which we think will make the difference!

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 8th

TOLEDO by 14 over Eastern Michigan Since 2000 UT is 20-3 SU vs EM but are just 5-2 SU & 1-6 ATS s/'16 & Visitor has won L/3 SU (2-1 ATS). EM is 4-5 SU (5-4 ATS) and need to win 2 of their L/3 to make their 3rd straight bowl. Toledo is 8-1 SU (4-5 ATS) incl 5-0 SU (2-3 ATS) in MAC & has a 2 game lead in MAC West. Against 4 common foes EM is 2-2 SU & ATS being out scored by 4 ppg & outgained by 71 ypg. Toledo is 4-0 SU with an avg 11 ppg & 112 ypg edges but are 0-4 ATS. UT is the more talented team however, UT has opened as close to a 3 td HF but are just 1-4 ATS vs FBS foes as DD chalk & EM is on a 12-1 ATS run (6 outright upsets) as a MAC road dog, so we will take the road dog here.

Bowling Green by 12 over KENT ST - Play for the Anniversary Trophy. BG won 5 straight (4-1 ATS) from '13-'17 but Kent ST has won the last 5 (4-1 ATS) incl a 40-6 win LY as a 2' pt AF. This however is a much different KS as they have a new HC with just 4 starters back & are just 1-8 this year. The Flashes best chance for an FBS win was last week vs Akron. They led 27-10 into the 4Q but then allowed 21 unanswered including a GW td with :26 left. BG on the other hand has won 3 straight MAC games. Falcons are 2-1 ATS as chalk, winning those 3 by over 17 ppg. The Flash are just 1-6-1 ATS as a dog this year losing by over 24 ppg. BG has rival Toledo on deck, but should be focused here as a win here would make them bowl eligible for just the 2nd time s/'16.

MIAMI, OH by 19 over Akron - MU has won 6 straight in series but the Visitor has covered last 5. LY RedHawks (-9) only led 7-3 late 2Q but thanks to a 62 yd IR td led 27-3 4Q & won 27-9. Zips despite being just 2-7 SU & 3-5-1 ATS are sky high as LW they ended a 4 game losing streak to rival Kent St despite trailing 27-10 4Q as they scored 21 unanswered to win 31-27. MU is off a 30-16 upset win as a 7' pt AD over rival Ohio & are tied for first in the MAC East with Buffalo. RedHawks are 7-2 SU & ATS incl 5-1 in MAC play. Against 2 common foes (BG & KS) MU is 2-0 SU/ATS, +23 ppg & +153 ypg while Akron is 1-1 SU/0-1-1 ATS, -11 ppg & -15 ypg. Miami has huge edges on offense #47 vs #126 and ST's (#1 vs #125)!

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 9th

LOUISVILLE by 24 over Virginia - UL looks to move one step closer to clinching a berth in the ACC Title game with a win here. LY UL only led 20-10 3Q but pulled away for 21 pt win (Pk) and finished w/a 473-319 yd edge. UVA was held to just 6 rush yds. The Cavaliers lost QB Muskett to inj early LW vs GTech. Bkp QB Colandrea led a td on his first drive but UVA trailed 24-10 at half and lost 45-17 (-1'). UL was an EASY 3★ LPS winner for us last week when they beat VTech 34-3 (-9). In the last 5 weeks UL has held foes to just 14.2 ppg and 226 ypg (68 rush) in their L/5. The Cards are 5-0 SU/ATS, +30 ppg and +220 ypg at home. UVA did upset NC and nearly beat Miami on the road but w/o Muskett this will be a tall task against this defense.

LOUISIANA by 17 over Southern Miss - Dating back to 1999 LA is 0-6 SU/ATS vs SMiss. LY in their first mtg as SBC foes where LA (-1) was +100 yds but SMiss scored 17 pts off 4 LA TO's and won 39-24. SMiss snapped a 7 gm losing streak LW, beating ULM 24-7 (+184 yds, +3 TO) while LA lost 37-17 at Ark St (-99 yds, -20 FD) and lost QB Chriss to a leg inj. SMiss is -188 ypg on the road this season and are allowing 443 ypg/37 ppg in SBC play. LA's rush attack leads their offense (198, 5.3) and SMiss's run D is allowing 185 (5.3) plus their pass ranks #104 and have all'd 313 pass ypg (62%) the L/3 gms. While LA has Troy on deck, they need a win to reach bowl eligibility and their other QB's have experience and we expect a bounce back performance.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 10th

SMU by 22 over North Texas - These two have played each year s/'14 as non-conf foes but meet for the first time since '07 as conf rivals. SMU is 7-1 SU/ATS in series and dominated NT LY 48-10 (-10'). SMU has won 5 straight but had their closest call LW, only beat Rice 36-31 (-12') despite a 477-290 yd edge. NT is just 3-6 but are +53 ypg vs the AAC and their last 3 games have been against 3 of the top 4 AAC teams (Tulane, Memphis, UTSA), all losses by 8 or less though NT actually trailed by 21,

21 & 17 at half in those games. Now they travel to SMU who is holding foes to 282 ypg and 82 ypg below their avg (#13 in FBS). NT's D is allowing 468 ypg and allows 98 ypg more than their foes avg (#133 in FBS). SMU did lose QB Stone to injury last week but bkp Kevin Jennings has hit 16 of 20 and 3 td's this year. We will go with the better D to actually stop NT from a 2H comeback.

UNLV by 3 over Wyoming - WY is on a 5-1 SU/ATS run vs UNLV, but their last meeting came in 2020 where WY (-16) r won 45-14. WY is off a rivalry win over CSU where they held them to 274 yds, while UNLV won 56-14 over NMex. In MW play UNLV has outgained every foe and are +83 ypg while WY is -69 ypg. WY's run D has struggled at times in MW play & are allowing 178 (5.1) while UNLV's offense is putting up 206 rush (4.8) in conf play. While WY's offense is led by RB Waylee (686, 6.0) UNLV's run D is allowing just 118 (3.7) in MW play. WY has played the tougher schedule (#69/#116), but UNLV is 8-1 ATS and are playing well and we'll take the Rebels here by a fg.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 11th

FLORIDA ATLANTIC by 7 over East Carolina - EC makes their first trip to Boca Raton. EC is now 1-8 this year but LW they only lost 13-10 (+17) vs #24 Tulane. Their largest loss in AAC play is 21 points vs SMU and they only trailed 14-10 late 3Q in that game. FAU needs to win 2 of their L/3 to get bowl eligible. FAU has the edge on offense & ST's but EC has a big edge on defense, holding foes 17 ypg below their avg. HC Houston is 13-6 as an AD and they did cover at UTSA a few weeks ago.

Alabama by 18 over KENTUCKY - Bama has won the L/7 mtgs including in '20, 63-3 (-32) and the visitor is 6-1 ATS in this series. KY led the whole way LW vs Miss St, winning 24-3 (-4). Bama held LSU & Tenn to just 7 2H points in their L/2 gms. QB Milroe rushed for 155 yds and 4 td's and Bama had a ssn high 288 rush and allowed a ssn low 2 sks. Bama is +57 ypg against our #2 sked while KY is +7 ypg but only against our #62 sked KY is no threat to pull the upset, even with Bama off LSU considering Stoops only has 2 career wins over SEC teams that finished w/a winning conf record. Bama only has FCS Chattanooga on deck so full focus is on this game and they are 6-2 ATS off LSU.

FLORIDA ST by 11 over Miami - The Dog has dominated this series, going 18-7 ATS with 12 outright upsets but FSU had none of that LY when they crushed the Canes 45-3 (-7). The home team is also just 6-11 SU/4-13 ATS. FSU enters 9-0 SU/6-3 ATS TY. They were w/o both WR's Coleman and Wilson LW and only beat Pitt 24-7 (-21') though QB Travis did throw for 360 yds and has a 19-2 ratio TY. QB Van Dyke has had a rough go since returning from injury. He has a 0-5 ratio in their L/2 and UM put up just 276 and 292 yds in those gms. He has just a 5-10 ratio in his L/4 starts yet this is still the same Miami team that beat A&M and Clem and led NCar at half. The 'Canes have the D (allow 311 ypg) to keep this competitive and if Van Dyke can avoid the crippling TO's we think UM stays within 2 td's.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 17 over Vanderbilt - SC is 28-4 SU in this series and has won 13 straight. We cashed our 4★ Newsletter play going against Vandy LW as part of our 5-1 day (Key Selections now 8-0 L2W!!!). The 'Dores are just 1-9 ATS this year and are -186 ypg vs the SEC. SC pulled out their 'Cock fight against JSU thanks to a late pick-6. QB Rattler threw for 399 yds and now faces a Vandy D that is #115 in our PDR (68%, 19-11) and has also allowed 202 rush ypg (5.7) in SEC play. SC still has a shot to get bowl elig and they've faced our #5 sked with only one game against a team with a losing record. The 'Cocks are 10-5 as a home chalk and will continue their series domination and win by over 2 td's.

NORTH CAROLINA by 20 over Duke - NC has won the last 5 mtgs but Duke just missed on pulling the upset last year as 7 pt dogs. Duke gets extra rest after beating Wake Forest 24-21 (-7) but they were outgained 400-267 and it was announced prior that QB Leonard would miss extended time. True frosh QB Grayson Loftis had his first career start and threw for just 86 yds against WF's pass D that was #80 in our PDR coming in, allowing 256 ypg. Duke has avg'd just 247 ypg in their L/3. NC is only off FCS Campbell and got back on the winning track after two straight losses as DD chalk. NC is +103 ypg vs ACC while Duke is -96. On one side you have a QB making his first true road start and on the other side you have a future #1 Draft Choice so we have a big lean on the Tar Heels.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 3 over Virginia Tech - The home team has won the L/4 mtgs with VT coming ahead last year 27-10 (-2'). Both teams have turned their seasons around after 1-3 starts. BC's goal of finishing 9-3 remains after beating Syracuse 17-10 (+3) last week despite a depleted RB unit that finished with their top three RB's all hurt. VT was off B2B wins but were no match for Louisville in a 34-3 (+9) road loss. VT is 0-4 SU/1-3 ATS and -100 ypg on the road with losses to Rutgers and Marshall. BC has won 5 close games this year while VT's wins are all by 17 points or more. We think this ends up being a close game which favors the battle tested Eagles but the injuries to their RB's have us in a wait-and-see approach.

WAKE FOREST by 3 over NC State - The home team has absolutely dominated this series, going 14-2 SU/ATS. NCSt pulled the upset last year at home, winning 30-21 (+3). WF caught Duke playing a true frosh QB, finished w/a 400-267 yd edge but couldn't pull the upset, losing 24-21 (+7). The Deacons missed 2 fgs, were SOD at the Duke 25 and int'd at the Duke 37 on their final poss. NCSt has pulled B2B outright upsets, beating Clemson & Miami at home but are now road favorites and they had just 202 & 231 yds in those wins. NCSt is bowl eligible while this is a must-win for WF to get to a bowl and with the home team's series edge we will go against the 'Pack in a flat spot.

CLEMSON by 15 over Georgia Tech - Clemson has won the L/8 in this series (6-1-1 ATS) including last year, beating Georgia Tech 41-10 (-24) in the opener. Clemson is a much better team than their 5-4 record, as shown by their 31-23 (+3) win over Notre Dame last week in which they led 24-6 2Q despite RB Shipley missing the game. GT was down 7-0 early at UVA LW but the 'Hoos QB was inj'd and GT ran away with it, 45-17 (+1'). Clemson is +86 ypg vs the ACC while GT is -14. The Jackets have rushed for 300 ypg in their L/3 but face a Clemson D that allows 108 rush (3.4). HC Swinney says if Clemson were a stock, "you better buy all you freaking can, Buy right now!" We completely agree, calling for the Tigers to win by over 2 td's.

JAMES MADISON by 21 over Connecticut - First meeting as FBS foes. Met 5 times from 1993-1999 with JMU winning 4 of the 5 gms. JMU kept their unbeaten season alive LW as they thrashed GSt 42-14 (+339 yds, +23 FD) while UConn fell 59-3 at Tenn (-394 yds). The L/4 gms UConn's defense is allowing 505 ypg incl 223 rush ypg (5.8) while JMU is avg'g 455 ypg the L/4 gms and are avg'g 295 pass yds in the L/4 gms and face a UConn pass D ranked #118 & are all'g 282 ypg (68%) over the L/4 gms. On offense UConn avg's just 291 ypg in the L/4 and face a strong JMU D that is giving up just 295 ypg in the L/4 and are giving up just 60 rush ypg (1.9) on the season. We don't see UConn keeping up with JMU, but the line is over 3 td's and this is a non-conf gm for JMU.

GEORGIA by 13 over Ole Miss - Ole Miss won the last meeting back in '16 45-14 (-7). UGA only led Mizzou 24-21 4Q LW but int'd QB Cook on their L/2 poss and won by 9. Ole Miss has won 5 straight and are 6-2-1 ATS this year while UGA is only 2-6-1 ATS. The Rebels did lead Bama at half on the road earlier TY but lost by 2 td's. RB Judkins had a slow start this year but he's topped 100 in 4 of their L/5 and UGA let Mizzou RB Schraeder top 100 LW. UGA has a big ST's edge (#3 vs #69 but Ole Miss has played the tougher sked (#14 vs #81). UGA is 27-15 ATS vs ranked foes while Ole Miss is 3-6 ATS vs ranked foes. We have a small lean on UGA as the line only opened at 10'.

The Under is 17-6 in Georgia's home games which puts this game in the mix for our Totals GOY!
Minnesota by 5 over PURDUE - Minn is 8-2 SU and 6-4 ATS in the L/10. LTH there were 5 lead changes w/Minn (+3', down 13-10 at HT) taking the lead for good holding on for a 20-13 win. Purdue (+32) is coming off their 4th straight B10 loss to Mich. The Boilermakers have covered 1 of L/4 in B10 play & are AVG 12 ppg. D is allowing 33 ppg and 388 ypg L/4. LW Minn (-2) gave up a TD w/ :50 left to fall to Illinois. Minn has inj's in their backfield but whoever gets the ball has been effective (5 RB's 100+yds). Minn has the motivation edge, needing a win to get bowl eligible while Pur already has 7 losses so we will take the Gophers in a close game.

Memphis by 6 over CHARLOTTE - First mtg between new AAC foes. Memphis has won their 3 road games by 14 ppg but are -1 ypg in those and -20 ypg vs the AAC. Biff Poggi got his team's attention by suspending multiple plyrs LW. It seemed to work as CLT beat Tulsa 33-26 (+4) on the road. Memphis led USF 59-42 but gave up a backdoor cover td w/ :55 left. CLT is 0-3 SU and -79 ypg at home but they are +33 ypg vs AAC foes. CLT started w/o QB Trexler lvy last week and he faces a Memphis D that is allowing 44 ypg more than their foes avg (#113 in FBS) and in Memphis L/2 they've allowed 591 & 583 yds. Memphis has a huge game vs SMU on deck and the Tigers only have one AAC win by DD's.

Michigan by 6 over PENN ST - Michigan has won the last 2 mtgs (6-3 SU/7-2 ATS s'14). The higher ranked tm has won 5 in a row SU (4-1 ATS). LY Mich (-7) was down early in the 3Q 17-16 but then scored 25 straight, dominating in the trenches (418-111 rush yd edge). PSU HC Franklin is 13-31 vs Top 25 incl an 8 pt loss to OSU (+4) 3 wks ago. Both D's rank Top 15 in our PDR but UM is avg 45 ppg in B10 play (PSU 33 ppg). PSU struggled in their last home gm against Indy (-31') winning 33-24 but at MD LW (-8), QB Allar looked great with 25-34-240-4-0 winning 51-15. UM (-32') easily beat Purdue 41-13 but were backdoored on a td w/ :18 left. Mich has the offense & ST's edge and won't need to steal signs to win this road matchup.

USF by 11 over Temple - The visitor is 1-8 SU/3-5 ATS and USF has covered 4 of the last 6 in this series but Temple pulled the upset LY, winning 54-28 as 3' pt dogs. Temple got QB Warner back from inj LW and it clearly made a difference in their 32-18 (+7) home upset of Navy. In Warner's 2 game absence Temple put up 14 pts and 478 yds. LW Warner threw for 402 and Temple finished w/ a 448-268 yd edge. USF led Memphis briefly in the 3Q but was down 17 until a td w/ :55 left in a 59-50 (+13') loss. USF is allowing 459 ypg including 306 pass ypg but Temple is allowing 433 ypg including 200 rush ypg. Temple also has the worst Pass D in the country, allowing a 21-1 ratio TY so we like USF to win a high scoring game by DD's.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 3 over Texas St - CC is 3-1 SU but 1-3 ATS vs TXSt and the home team has failed to cover all 4. CC started back qb Guest 2 wks ago & LW started a different bkp QB in Ethan Vasko who had 350 yds (180 pass, 170 rush) in a win at ODU while TXSt is bowl eligible for the 1st time! TXSt avg's 273 ypg (68%) in SBC play led by QB Finley (69%, 18-5 ratio) but CC's pass D ranks #38 (14-12 ratio). While TXSt does avg 201 rush ypg (5.0) CC is allowing just 130 rush ypg (4.3) in conf play. TXSt is also -5 TO's in the L/4 gms while CC is +4 TO's. Despite the loss of QB McCall CC has put up 427 yds & 458 yds the L/2 gms and have the huge edge on D (#63/#107).

Appalachian St by 3 over GEORGIA ST - App St is 9-0 SU/6-2-1 ATS vs GSt. App St is the dog here & that snaps a streak of 18 straight as an SBC favorite. App is off a 31-9 win vs Marsh while GSt was blown out by JMU 42-14 (-339 yds, -23 FD!). App's run D is allowing 205 ypg (5.5) vs SBC foes & GSt relies on their run game (a 182, 4.9 in SBC). App ST's offense does put up 461 ypg/33 ppg in conf and are led by QB Aguilar (64%, 23-6), RB Noel is back and GSt does have the #120 pass D. While App's D has struggled at times TY (456 ypg vs SBC) they are +5 ypg in SBC play while GSt is -69 ypg and GSt is -92 ypg at home TY while App is +53 ypg on the road. We like App to get the outright win.

Georgia Southern by 6 over MARSHALL - 8th meeting, but just 2nd as FBS foes. MU is now 0-5 SU/ATS in SBC gms this season after a 31-9 loss to App while GSt lost at TXSt 45-24. This season the GSthrn pass attack is again rolling as they are avg'g 307 ypg (66%) and while MU has the #46 pass D, they are allowing 254 pass ypg the L/4 gms and gave up 289 yds to Coastal's new QB 2 wks ago. While GSthrn's D is giving up 442 ypg vs SBC foes, in their L/3 gms MU is avg'g just 232 ypg/8 ppg and have been outscored 95-24. GSthrn's pass rush has 12 sks the L/3 wks & MU has all'd 13 sks the L/3 gms. Given MU's slide in conf play, we'll back GSthrn here to get the win.

WISCONSIN by 10 over Northwestern - Teams have met every yr s/ '13. UW is 6-4 SU but 4-6 ATS. In 4 of the 6 covers NU has been the outright winner. Coming off a home loss to OSU the Badgers were on the road taking on Indiana (-9), getting upset 20-14 despite net +83 yds but were playing w/o their top 2 RB's. NW played at Wrigley Field last week (+5') & lost 10-7 vs Iowa. UW leading RB Allen is battling an ankle sprain and is ? for this game & QB Locke has been completing under 50% in his three starts but does have a 5-1 ratio. UW has struggled to cover at home (1-4) & NW has covered L/3 in B10 play.

IOWA by 3 over Rutgers - The fourth matchup for these B10 foes, Iowa is 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS. The defense for Iowa came in clutch in LY's meeting, IR & FR for TDs, winning 24-10 despite only putting up 277 yds of offense. The Hawkeye defense had another stellar outing vs NW last week (170 yds all'd) while their offense struggled again (169 yds gained). RU is off a home loss (+19) to OSU, they did have a 9-6 lead at half & held them to 101 yds below their ssn avg. RU is 6-2-1 ATS on the year & 11-3-1 as an AD (HC Shiano 32-19-2). We expect the Knights to keep it close.

BOISE ST by 21 over New Mexico - Boise is 6-0 SU/4-1-1 ATS in their L/6 vs NMex with the avg MOV being 27 ppg. Boise has allowed 400+ yds in 4 of 5 MW gms, but in the past 4 mtgs have held

NMex to just 194 ypg. NMex's hope reaching a bowl are almost gone after their 56-14 loss LW to UNLV, while Boise still needs 2 wins to reach a bowl. NMex's run D has struggled at times TY (181, 5.7 in MW play) and now face a Boise rush attack avg'g 230 (5.5) in MW play but RB Jeanty DNP LW (CS). Boise's pass D does struggle (#108) but their run D is allowing just 95 ypg (3.4) in MW play. Boise has the edge in all 3 phases plus they have played the tougher sked (#72/#118). With NMex just 3-7 ATS in MW road gms the L3Y, we'll take Boise by 3 td's.

Arizona by 6 over COLORADO - AZ is on quite the tear following their 3rd straight upset win LW vs UCLA where they finished w/a 429-271 yd edge and helped deliver our Top 4★ LP Total Winner on the Under 50' (UA now 8-1 ATS on the yr!). They now head into Boulder to take on a Buffs squad that dropped a 7 pt home meeting against OSU (held to 229 yds under ssn avg) a wk ago for their 5th loss in 6 gms (CU under .500 for 1st time TY!). AZ has won 8 of the L/11 in the series including a 43-20 (-17') home win LY where they put up a ssn-high 673 yds! This is a rare role for UA in this one however as they've been an AF on just 1 occasion over the past 4 ssn (21-20 win at Stanford TY as nearly 2 TD chalk). With the Buffs covering 4 of their 5 as a dog on the ssn and taking on a warm-weathered squad at home in November, we're cutting off our lean at less than a TD for the visitor.

Iowa St by 10 over BYU - ISU has won all 4 previous meetings. BYU's offense has been largely 1 dimensional TY, avg'g just 80 rush ypg (2.9) while throwing for 218 ypg. However, ISU allows just 118 rush ypg (3.6) and they have the #5 ranked pass D (55%, 12-13 ratio). BYU started new QB Retzlaff LW and he hit just 50% vs WVU. Overall BYU is putting up 82 ypg under what their foes allow (#128) and are avg'g just 292 ypg in B12 play. ISU's D is holding foes to 68 ypg under their avg (#19). While BYU is 4-0 SU at home TY, they are -49 ypg at home while ISU is +24 ypg on the road & BYU is -166 ypg in B12 play. ISU is also 4-2 ATS in B12 play & we think they go into Provo and get the win.

UTAH ST by 14 over Nevada - First meeting since 2020 where Nev won 34-9, but USU has won 3 of the L/5 SU. USU is off a 2 OT win at SDSt while Nev lost outright vs Haw 27-14. USU has thrown 277 ypg (62%) in MW play and now take on a Nev pass D ranked #132 as they are allowing 273 ypg (68%). In MW play Nev is -77 ypg while USU is +42 ypg. The Aggies are also +145 ypg at home and avg 575 ypg at home. USU has the edge on offense (#53/#131) and ST (#79/#106) plus the Aggies need a win here to keep bowl hopes alive and Nev is only avg'g 297 ypg in MW play, but we'll cut off our lean on USU at 2 td.

CALIFORNIA by 3 over Washington St - The Cougs continued their losing skid with a 5th consec SU/ATS defeat LW in Pullman against Stanford who held them to just 7 pts and 245 yds in a 3 pt loss (WSU had avg 32 ppg & 435 ypg on the yr). They now travel to take on a Cal squad that suffered a 44 pt beatdown LW in Eugene with 32-16 FD and 597-286 yd deficits (NC Sports Monday Early Bird comp now 7-3 on the ssn!). WSU has shut down the Bears offense each of the L2Y including a 28-9 (-4) win LY in the Palouse where QB Ward threw for 343 yds and 3 TD's (also int'd twice in Cal EZ). The HT in this series has won 5 of the L/6 (4-2 ATS) while Cal is also on an 11-4 ATS run in Berkeley. Cal has actually played our #1 schedule strength (WSU #26). With WSU failing to cover all 3 of their P12 AG's TY, the Bears get the edge in this one.

WASHINGTON by 4 over Utah - After a shootout victory LW in LA to remain unbeaten (RB Johnson 26-256-9-8-4), UW returns home where they've failed to cover 4 of their L/6 P12 contests incl a narrow 15-7 (-27') win 3 wks ago against ASU (trailed 7-6 in 4Q). Utah rebounded from a rare loss in SLC a wk prior against UO w/a 52 pt blowout LW against Ariz ST where QB Barnes threw for 4 TD's (Utah 26-6 FD & 513-83 yd edges). UW has won 13 of 15 all-time vs the Utes (4-5 ATS s'11) including a narrow 24-21 (-7) victory in their most recent matchup (20). With the favorite on just a 3-6 ATS run and Utah 14-3 as an AD dating back to '14, another one score gm should be in the offing.

UCLA by 10 over Arizona St - ASU saw their 5-gm ATS winning streak snapped LW at Utah (held to just 3 pts, 6 FD's and 83 tll yds in the 52 pt defeat). They're now back on the road to face UCLA who was held to just 10 pts and 271 yds in a 17 pt loss at Ariz. Following a surprising home upset loss in '21 where they were ranked at #20, UCLA (-11) earned revenge with 571 yds and a ssn-best 50 pts. While their D has been one of the best (13th in FBS w/16.3 ppg & 294 ypg all'd), UCLA is just 7-14 ATS as a HF (vs FBS) in HC Kelly's tenure. With ASU having success as an AD (12-5 ATS) despite LW's effort, we expect them to stay inside the spread in what could be a low-scoring affair.

OREGON ST by 31 over Stanford - OSU got back on track a week ago in Boulder following just their 2nd loss of the ssn as they finished with 25-15 FD and 418-238 yd edges. Stanford meanwhile are in the Pacific NW for a 2nd straight week. Stanford's trip to Pullman LW was a shocking one as they held the Cougs to just a TD in a 10-7 upset victory (+13'). After losing 11 straight in this series from '10-'20 (15 pt avg defeat), OSU has put together B2B wins including a 28-27 (-5) win LY where they trailed 17-7 at HT and got a GW TD with :13 remaining (442-359 yd edge). With Reser Stadium continuing to be a "House of Horrors" for the visitor (OSU 16-1 SU/ATS L3Y), OSU get a big MOV here (Cardinal 4-8 ATS as an AD) before welcoming a potential undefeated UW squad a week later.

While Lib has covered 7 of 9 gms TY, ODU has covered 6 straight as a dog and we see them hanging around as their L/8 gms have been decided by 7 pts or less & both of LU's non-covers TY were as DD favorites, plus ODU has faced the tougher sked (#78/#110). **FORECAST: Liberty by 6**

LOUISIANA TECH by 6 over Sam Houston - LT is 2-0-1 all-time vs their new CUSA rival, winning the last mtg in 1999. The Bulldogs have lost their last 2 on Sr Day. SH had to come from behind to beat Kennesaw St LW 24-21 (-17) in a game they trailed 21-7 at half. Five of SH's last 6 games have been decided by 7 pts or less. The Bulldogs will miss out on a bowl for the 4th straight season after losing 59-30 (+15) at Liberty last week. LT is +61 ypg at home while SH is -164 ypg on the road but only -33 ypg vs CUSA and it only makes sense that SH plays a close game again.

KANSAS ST by 28 over Baylor - LY's 31-3 win by KSt snapped a 4 gm losing streak. The home team is on an 0-7 ATS run. KSt's run game is avg'g 221 (5.3) in B12 play and here face a Baylor run D giving up 196 (5.3) in B12 play. In conf play KSt is +67 ypg/+16 ppg while BU is -48 ypg/-11 ppg and now have 7 losses and cant make a bowl. BU also has the #110 pass D and KSt threw for 327 yds LW vs a Texas pass D ranked #21. KSt has covered 8 straight home games and, KSt has outscored their L/2 B12 foes in home 82-3 and they are angry off a loss and now face a team that could be packing it in.

UTSA by 17 over Rice - UTSA has won all 7 meetings in CUSA play and now face off as AAC Rivals. The Roadrunners have also covered the L/4 mtgs and won the last two by a combined 86-7! UTSA is 5-0 in AAC play, with all 5 wins coming by at least 8 points. LW they led NT 37-21 (-8) but allowed a late td and 2 pt conv. UTSA ran for 287 yds and Rice just gave up 223 rush (5.0) vs SMU in their 36-31 (+12) loss. The Owls were outgained 477-290 and out FD'd 26-13 with QB Daniels leaving due to injury (check status). UTSA is +67 ypg in AAC play while Rice is -76. We already were leaning with UTSA but if Daniels can't go we like the Roadrunners even more.

ILLINOIS by 7 over Indiana - Both teams coming off upset road wins and need to win for bowl eligibility so this should be a tight game. The winning team has covered 15 straight in this series including Indiana winning the last four. LY in the ssn opener Indiana (-1) down 20-16 scored a TD w/ :23 left to take down the Illini 23-20, despite getting outgained 448-362. LW at Minn (+2), backup QB Paddock threw TD w/ :50 left to pull off the road win 27-26. The Illini got DT Newton back in the 2H and allowed just 69 yds in the 2H. IU is coming off a road upset win to Wisconsin, QB Sorsby has 7-1 ratio including 19-31-186-1-0 LW but we like Illinois' D to control this game for a td win.

Troy by 24 over ULM - Troy has won at covered 3 of the L/4 meetings, but LTH in '21 ULM (+23) pulled the outright upset 29-16. Troy QB Watson is having a good season (61%, 17-4 ratio) and now faces the #102 pass D that is all'g 287 ypg in SBC play. ULM also allows 196 rush (5.0) in SBC play & now face Troy RB Vidal (1119, 5.7). ULM put up just 250 yds vs Sala & 285 vs TXSt, and here faces a Troy D all'g just 296 ypg/10 ppg in SBC play & are holding foes 105 ypg under their avg (#2). Overall ULM is -125 ypg/-15 ppg in SBC play while Troy is +132 ypg/+18 ppg. ULM is a tough home dog (7-3 ATS) but Troy has covered 5 straight and we'll take them by over 3 td's.

ARKANSAS by 6 over Auburn - Aub had their 7 game series win streak end LY at home when Ark won 41-27 (-3'). The Tigers have covered 5 of L/7 mtgs and the home team is 0-4 ATS. Ark made a change at OC and put up a ssn high 481 yds LW, keeping their bowl hopes alive by beating FL in OT 39-36 (+3). We cashed our 4★ PS play and a 3★ LPS in Auburn's 31-15 (-12) win over Vandy LW. The Tigers finally settled on a QB with Peyton Thorne getting every snap and they've topped 400 yds in B2B games. RB Sanders made a surprise return for Ark LW and ran for 103 yds and Aub did give up over 200 rush on 3 occasions. We like the rejuvenated Hogs to pull together and win another close game.

LSU by 4 over Florida - The Dog is 6-1 SU/ATS in this series. LSU put everything they had into LW's loss at Bama and now Jayden Daniels is a ? (concussion). The Tigers defense struggled once again, allowing 42 pts and 507 yards including 288 rush. FL will need to pull an upset to get bowl eligible, traveling to Mizzou and closing at home vs FSU. QB Mertz does have a 17-2 ratio and is completing 74%. The Gators D has struggled lately, allowing 443 ypg but LSU didn't score after Daniels left last week. All of LSU's goals are pretty much shot, while FL is angry off a loss to Ark in OT. All 9 LSU games have gone Over the Vegas Total including LW when we cashed a 4★ on the Over vs Bama and if Daniels is healthy this would certainly be in the mix for our Totals GOY!

OKLAHOMA by 6 over West Virginia - Before LY, WVU was 0-9 SU vs OU, but pulled the upset LY 23-20. LTH WVU (+17) won 16-13 in the final play. WVU's offense has picked up the L/4 gms, avg'g 510 ypg and take on an OU D that has all'd 462 ypg the L/4. WVU's run gm is avg'g 227 ypg (5.0) in B12 play & just ran for 336 (7.0) LW vs BYU in a 37-7 win where we picked up a 3★ PS winner! OU's run D has all'd 161 (4.3) in B12 play. OU's offense avg's 468 ypg in B12 play but WVU has the #26 pass D (58%, 17-9). WVU has pulled two B12 road upsets TY and we see them keeping this game close!

Texas by 10 over TCU - As Big 12 foes TCU is 7-3 SU/ATS vs Texas & TCU has pulled the outright upset in 3 of the L/4. Texas escaped vs KSt LW as they were up 27-7 late 3Q but TO's all'd KSt back & Texas won 33-30 in OT. TCU QB Hoover has topped 350+ yds in 2 of 3 starts but has a 5-5 ratio and here faces the #21 pass D (12-10 ratio all'd). Texas bkp QB Murphy is hitting 56% (3-1) but Texas has RB Brooks (1034, 6.3) and TCU's run D is allowing 199 (4.7) the L/4 gms. TCU is +83 ypg in B12 play while Texas is +121 ypg, but TCU is -1 ppg and Texas is +16 ppg. Texas does have the ST edge (#4/#75) and the sked edge (#18/#58). TCU is now on a 1-4 SU/ATS run and we'll back Texas by DD's.

TEXAS A&M by 24 over Mississippi St - A&M has lost the last 2 in this series but they go from being 4 pt dogs last year to -18 this year. The Aggies did win by 14 & 19 in their two wins in '19-'20. A&M had their gm tying fg blocked at the end of reg LW at Ole Miss, losing 38-35 (+3). The Aggies 3 SEC losses are all by 7 pts or less vs top 15 tms (Bama/Tenn/Ole Miss). Miss St had just 218 yds LW in a 24-3 home loss to KY. The Bulldogs are -76 ypg in SEC play while A&M is +72 ypg in SEC play. Miss St has the lowest rated Power-5 Pass D in our PDR (#126, 230 ypg, 73%, 16-6) and Max Johnson did throw for a ssn high 305 last week. MSU is on a 1-7 ATS run and we like A&M by over 3 td's.

HOUSTON by 3 over Cincinnati - Former AAC foes, meet for the 1st time as Big 12 foes. These teams are a combined 2-10 SU/4-7-1 ATS in Big 12. UH still has hopes of a bowl after beating Baylor LW while Cincy dropped their 7th in a row. UH QB Smith is hitting 66% (18-7) and faces a Cincy pass D allowing 259 ypg (15-4) in B12 play. Cincy's QB Jones has a 9-10 ratio vs FBS foes & while Cincy is avg'g 219 ypg rush (5.2) in B12 play, UH is giving up 159 rush (3.9) the L/4 gms. UH has played the tougher sked (#11/#43) and still have something to play for, so we'll take them by a FG.

Tulane by 24 over Tulsa - Tulane has won 4 of the last 6 meetings including LY 27-13 (-7) when they finished w/a 482-257 yd edge. The Green Wave are on a 1-6 ATS run after only beating ECU 13-10 (-17) last week. Tulsa has lost 4 straight. They were upset at home (-4) by CLT 33-26 last week. QB Williams was inj'd in the 2Q and bkp QB Braxton was benched in the 3Q for W/O Kirk Francis. Tulsa is 10-2-1 ATS vs ranked teams and Tulane hasn't gotten distance on teams, with their largest

FBS win coming by just 20 points but the QB situation at Tulsa has us leaving this right at the line. **WKU by 5 over New Mexico St** - First mtg. The winner of this game likely gets to play in the CUSA Title game. WKU only had 280 yds and 11 FD's but managed to beat UTEP 21-13 (-9). NMSt has won 5 straight and have clinched their 2nd straight bowl under HC Kill. The Aggies are -21 ypg on the road with losses at Hawaii and Liberty and only beat LT by 3. WKU is 3-1 SU and +13 ypg at home. We will take the 'Toppers to win a close game.

Pittsburgh by 6 over SYRACUSE - Two disappointing tms meet at Yankee Stadium in NYC. Pitt is 16-2 SU/13-5 ATS in this series. Pitt lost 24-7 (+21) at home vs FSU last week but could have been closer. Pitt WR Bub Means fumbled while crossing the EZ. Cuse was w/o QB Shrader LW in their 17-10 (-3) loss to BC. Bkp QB Del Rio-Wilson threw for just 37 yards, had 4 int's and was hobbled late. The Orange are -259 ypg in their 5 game losing streak. Pitt has 24 sacks and will make life uncomfortable for whoever starts at QB and Babers is 4-21 SU when playing a backup QB.

NAVY by 3 over Uab - First mtg. This is UAB's first game vs a Service Academy member since 2004. Both teams enter 3-6. Navy was upset by Temple 32-18 (-7) last week, getting outgained 448-268 while USF pulled an upset over FAU 45-42. QB Zeno returned from injury and had a career game, throwing for 484 and 5 td's. Navy allowed Temple's EJ Warner to throw for 402. UAB allows 200 rush ypg (5.3). UAB has played the tougher sked (#76 vs #120) and the Blazers are +57 ypg vs AAC foes while Navy is -66 ypg vs AAC foes. Navy did beat North Texas at home earlier this year and UAB is defending the triple option with an inexperienced coordinator so we will call for Navy to win by a fg.

NEBRASKA by 3 over Maryland - This is only the 3rd mtg in this series (L/met in '19). MD after starting off 5-0 has fallen to the bottom of the B10 East after dropping 4 straight SU/ATS. LW vs PSU (+8) MD lost 51-15 and was held to a ssn low 234 yds. Neb (-3) was -3 TO's & with inj's to their o-line allowed 7 sacks, getting upset at Mich St 20-17. At home Neb is scoring 24 PPG (15 on road) & beat Purdue by 17 two weeks ago. Both tms need a win to get bowl elig but with Neb at home and looking for their first bowl since '16 we will call for the 'Huskies to pull the outright upset.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 7 over Fiu - FIU is 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS at Murfreesboro. MT is officially staying home for bowl season after losing 13-7 at New Mex St last week. FIU still needs two wins to get to a bowl with Ark & WKU on deck so this is a must win. MT is only -29 ypg vs CUSA foes while FIU is -149. The home team is 7-3 SU/8-2 ATS and the Over is 14-4 in this series but we will give MT a 7 point edge at home and lean with the underdog Panthers.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 17 over Arkansas St - SALa has won and covered the L/4 gms against Ark St. Ark St is off a 37-17 upset win vs LA where they put up 426 yds. SALa is now 4-5 and in danger of missing a bowl. LW they lost to rival Troy 28-10 and QB Bradley was inj'd and true frosh QB Gio Lopez started (17-27-155, 0-1) but Bradley should be back. In SBC play SALa is +158 ypg while Ark St is -63 ypg. Ark St's D is also allowing foes to gain 45 ypg above their avg (#114) while SALa is holding foes to 79 ypg under their avg (#16). SALa is led by RB Webb (727, 5.4, 14 td) and Ark St is giving up 197 rush ypg (5.2) in SBC play. We think SALa bounces back and win with 2+ td's.

COLORADO ST by 7 over San Diego St - SDSt has won 4 of the L/5 mtgs, but last met in 2020 where SDSt (-8) won 29-17 at home. This is a meaningful game for both teams as the loser is eliminated from bowl contention. SDSt dropped a 2OT game to Utah St LW while CSU lost at rival Wyoming. While SDSt ranks #37 in the PDR, they did allow 427 to Hawaii earlier TY and CSU relies on their pass game (267 ypg vs MW) as they are avg'g just 74 rush ypg (3.1) in MW play. SDSt is only putting up 326 ypg in conf play & CSU has all'd just 375 ypg the L/4 gms. We think at home, the Rams are the better team and get the win.

OHIO ST by 38 over Michigan State - The Buckeyes are 16-3 SU including 7-0 SU & 6-1 ATS vs MSU. OSU has not trailed in a game s/ '15 (MSU 17-14) with an avg 29.7 MOV. MSU as a dog of +15 or more have covered 2 of L/10. OSU with a win LW vs Rutgers (5th straight cover), in 2nd gm back from inj RB Henderson 208 all-purpose yds. MSU (+3) vs Neb pulled out the win (20-17), thanks to 7 sacks and allowed just 283yds! QB's Houser/Leavitt will have a rough time against OSU's Pass D that is #1 in our PDR (50%, 7-6). The Bucks are 3-0 ATS vs FBS foes at home TY and MSU already has a 49 pt loss to Mich but we are right at the line at press time.

Air Force by 24 over HAWAII - Have not met since 2019 where AF won 56-26 win. AF had their unbeaten season ended LW vs Army where they were -6 TO's in a 23-3 loss and we picked up a 2★ PS winner & 3★ LP winner on Army! UH went to Nev and pulled the upset 27-14. UH is allowing 206 rush ypg (4.8) in MW play & AF is avg'g 330 rush (5.5) in conf play. AF is allowing just 85 rush ypg in MW play & their pass D comes in #74. AF still is in the drivers seat for the MW title game, and off a loss will be refocused and Hawaii could run into a buzzsaw here as AF is 4-1 ATS in MW play.

TUESDAY NOVEMBER 14th
Akron at EASTERN MICHIGAN - Eagles have won 3 straight vs the Zips and are 2-1 ATS only coming up just short of covering last year winning 34-28 as a 7 pt HF. Eagles need a win here if they want to be bowl eligible for a 2nd straight season, while Zips will be playing out their sixth straight losing season. Eagles are just 6-2 SU & 1-7 ATS as a favorite the L/2 years but have a lot more to play for. Will this be our Tuesday Nite Marquee? Find out after Noon EST on Tuesday.

Toledo at BOWLING GREEN - The 88th "Battle of I-75" a very tight series with Toledo leading 42-41-4 thanks to winning 11 of the L/13. This will be the 8th straight ssn BG comes in as the dog but they are 4-3 ATS with 2 outright upsets including a 42-35 win last year as a 15' pt AD. Toledo is just 5-3 ATS as chalk but BG is just 3-3 ATS as a dog TY. MAction games have a tendency to be high scoring, and this series has gone over 6 of L/8 mtgs incl a com'd 77 pts LY.

Western Michigan at NORTHERN ILLINOIS - If WM lost to Rival C.Mich then they are just closing out the season under a first year HC, however if they beat CM then both those teams are playing for a bowl. NIU is 10-4 SU & 9-5 ATS vs WM but have lost 2 of L/3 (2-1 ATS). LY the lead changed on all 7 combined scores with NIU topping off a 73 yd GW td drive with :56 left to win 24-21. This is a MAction series that actually trends to the under (7-3) incl going under 4 of the L/5. With 3 games to choose from we'll pick out the best for our Tuesday Nite Marquee available Tuesday after Noon EST, just \$10 at ncsports.com or \$12 through the office at 1-800-654-3448.

2★ Tennessee over TAMPA BAY - The Titans are in the middle of a 3-gm road trip following a narrow 4 pt loss last Thur in PIT (QB Levis 22-39-262-0-1 in 2nd car st) and a trip to DIV rival JAX on deck. TB meanwhile is at home for the only time in a 5-wk span following road losses to BUF and HOU (Texans GW 15-9 yd TD pass w/:10 left, TB outgained 496-333) with trips to SF and IND on deck. The Bucs have dropped 3 straight in this series (SU & ATS) including a '19 trip to Nashville where the Titans (-2) took advantage of 4 TB TO's in the 27-23 win (Bucs 23-16 FD & 389-246 yd edges). With the Titans also covering 7 of their past 10 meetings with NFC foes and the Bucs struggling in their own non-conf matchups (2-6 ATS), the visitor gets the narrow victory in this one (TB 2-6-1 ATS as a HF). **FORECAST: Tennessee by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

Carolina at CHICAGO - Thursday - This marks the only HG for the Bears in a 5-wk span following a pair of road losses against the Chargers and Saints (5-0 TO deficit in 7 pt defeat, CHI 368-301 yd edge) with trips to DIV rivals DET and MIN on deck. The Panthers head into Soldier Field following a home loss against the Colts with rookie QB Young throwing 3 int's in the 14 pt defeat. The Bears have won 5 of the past 6 (3-3 ATS) including a 23-6 (+1) upset win in Charlotte back in '20. While CHI has struggled in HG's by failing to cover 6 of the L/9, the Panthers have failed to cover all 4 of their road matchups on the year with a 16 pt avg defeat. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

† Indianapolis by 4 over New England - Frankfurt, Germany. The Colts head into Frankfurt after ending a 3-gm losing LW in Charlotte despite a 275-198 yd disadvantage (+2 TO's). The Patriots meanwhile suffered a 3 pt loss LW in Foxboro against the Commanders (+3) who finished with a 431-327 yd edge. NE has taken 2 previous trips across the Atlantic with London victories in both '09 and '12 while the Colts lost their only England contest back in '16. Including a pair of playoff games, the Patriots have won 9 of the L/10 meetings with the Colts (6-4 ATS). In their matchup a year ago, the Colts (+5) were held to just 8 FD's and 121 yards in a 26-3 defeat. While NE is a strong 8-3 ATS prior to a week off, they are on a very porous 2-11 ATS run dating back to LY. With IND also an impressive 8-2 ATS before a bye, we'll give them a small lean in this one as the Pats are just 3-13 ATS in recent roles as a dog.

BALTIMORE by 10 over Cleveland - Following a 4th consecutive win (3-1 ATS) LW against the Seahawks (29-6 FD & 515-151 yd edges in 34 pt win) in their 1st of 3 straight HG's, the Ravens (7-2 for 4th time in franchise history) welcome a Browns team that picked up a home victory of their own a week ago against the Cardinals with their 1st shutout since '07 (CLE all'd just 7 FD's, 58 tt yds, forced 3 TO's and had 7 sks!). In their Wk 4 meeting earlier TY in CLE, the Ravens (-2) held the Browns to just 3 pts and 166 yds in the 25 pt blowout win. While BAL has gone just 5-10 ATS against AFC North foes overall and 4-8 ATS as a HF, Deshaun Watson did look a little shaky with a handful of his passes in his return from inj a week ago (CLE 2-6 ATS as a DIV AD).

CINCINNATI by 11 over Houston - The Bengals look like a completely different team following their bye 2 weeks ago as a now healthy QB Burrow guided them to a DD road win in SF and an 8 pt victory LW at home against the Bills where we picked up a Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner (Burrow 31-44-348-2-0). CIN now welcomes a Texans squad that picked up a narrow 2 pt home win (GW 15-9 yd TD pass w/:10 left) a week ago against the Bucs with QB Stroud continuing his march to unanimous Off ROY honors (470 pass yds & 5 TD's). After losing the 1st 3 matchups in this series, the Texans have won 8 of the past 10 against the Bengals including playoff games in both '11 and '12. While HOU has covered 4 of their L/6 coming in, it's also worth mentioning that they're just 5-10-1 ATS as a NDIV AD. With the Bengals 8-2-1 ATS as home chalk and 17-4-1 ATS overall dating back to the early part of LY, we'll go ahead an lean in their direction.

New Orleans by 6 over MINNESOTA - This marks the only HG in a 3-wk span for the Vikings who are fresh off of trips to GB (14 pt win) and ATL (3 pt comeback win, bkp QB Dobbs 224 tt yds, 3 TD's in relief of inj'd QB Hall) with another trip to "Mile High" on deck. The Saints meanwhile picked up their 2nd straight win LW against the Bears thanks in part to a 5-0 TO edge (CHI 368-301 yd advantage). In their London matchup a year ago, the Vikings (-4) got a GW 47-yd FG with :24 left for the 28-25 victory. With MIN failing to cover 5 of their L/6 home matchups, we're giving the Saints the lean here as they're 5-1-2 ATS in recent road contests while covering 6 of their L/7 prior to a bye week.

PITTSBURGH by 7 over Green Bay - Rematch of Super Bowl XLV ('10), a game that saw the Packers take advantage of 3 Steelers TO's in the 31-25 win (PIT 387-338 yd edge). Speaking of the "Big Game", the Steelers are actually the only tm in the SB era to have a winning record thru 8 gms (4 pt win last Thur vs TEN) despite being outgained in every matchup TY (-99 ypg). GB meanwhile had dropped 4 in a row SU and ATS prior to a 20-3 win LW in Lambeau against a Rams squad w/o QB Stafford (Packers 21-10 FD & 391-187 yd edges). The most recent meeting came back in '21 where the Packers (-6) earned a 27-17 victory (GB 23-17 FD & 367-282 yd edges). TD pass with :27 left. The Falcons have won 4 of the past 5 meetings with the Cardinals (SU & ATS) including a 20-19 (-6) home win LY where they kicked a GW 21-yd FG at the buzzer. With ARZ going a solid 4-1 ATS in HG's coming in and likely getting the return of Kyler Murray under center, the Falcons may be handed a defeat in the desert (ATL 2-6 ATS in recent AG's) ending the Cardinals' 6-gm losing skid.

The Seahawks also played on the East Coast LW in BAL with the Ravens finishing with 29-6 FD and 515-151 yd edges in an easy 37-3 victory. In their most recent matchup back in '21, WAS would hold the Seahawks to just 10 FD's and 267 yards in the 17-15 victory.
