4★ BOISE ST over BYU - Boise has won 8 of 12 mtgs, but BYU is 8-4 ATS in those mtgs. BYU has taken a nose dive the L/4 gms as they have lost 4 straight. Boise on the other hand has won 4 straight. In the L/4 gms Boise is +235 ypg/+22 ppg while BYU is -180 ypg/-14 ppg. Boise's run gm has improved the L/4 gms (208, 5.1) and BYU's run D has all'd 260 ypg (6.1) over the L/4 gms. Boise's D has played outstanding, holding tms to 113 ypg under their ssn avg (#6) & the L/4 gms have held tms to 197 ypg/14 ppg. BYU is also -75 ypg on the road this ssn while Boise is +266 ypg at home TY. 3★ North Carolina over VIRGINIA - LY NC put up a ssn high 699 yds against UVA and won 59-39 (-7). UVA is off a sad 14-12 (+3) 4OT loss to Miami where neither team reached the end zone the entire game. UVA is +66 ypg at home and their D is holding foes 56 ypg below their avg. NC trailed Pitt 24-14 3Q then scored the final 28 pts and finished +12 FD's to basically clinch the ACC Coastal. Similar to last week NC has a huge edge on offense but UVA has a huge edge on D. UVA has pl'y'd 3 straight against teams with bkp QB's and now face NC's Maye who has a 29-3 ratio. QB Armstrong has just a 6-9 ratio and the 'Hoos offense won't be able to match the Heels so we see a resounding victory for NC.

Both tms come in struggling 3-5 and with 4 gms to play they need to stack wins if they are to get to a bowl. ISU has yet to win a B12 gm but against B12 foes are +12 ypg/-6 ppg. The ISU DEF is keeping them in gms as they are holding foes 134 ypg under their ssn avg (#31) and are holding B12 foes 331 ypg. ISU's offense is only avg'g 343 ypg/16 ppg vs B12 foes but here WVU's DEF is struggling the L/4 gms as they are all'g 531 ypg/42 ppg incl 363 pass ypg & have the #114 pass D. WVU is just 1-4 ATS vs B12 foes TY and we'll side with the much better DEF & the team playing at home to get the win by over 2 td's.

FORECAST: IOWA ST by 16

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ MISSISSIPPI ST over Auburn - MSU upset Auburn on the Plains LY 43-34 (+4). MSU is off B2B road losses at KY & Bama with Rogers throwing just 1 td in those 2 games but he faces an Auburn D that he torched for 415 yds and 6 td's LY. Now that Auburn has a new AD, ironically taken from Miss St last week, maybe they will finally make a move to fire HC Harsin. Auburn has lost 4 straight, with the last 3 coming by DD's. They've allowed over 500 yds in 3 straight. MSU is +46 ypg and +160 ypg at home. MSU is 4-0 SU/ATS at home and beat Ark 40-17 while Auburn just lost 41-27 last week at home vs the Hogs. We've got MSU giving Harsin the nail in the coffin by more than 2 td's.

FORECAST: MISSISSIPPI ST by 17

2★ PITTSBURGH over Syracuse - The Panthers are 15-2 SU/12-5 ATS in this series and Cuse is 0-9 in Acrisure Stadium. Both tms enter off B2B losses. Pitt led NCar 24-14 3Q last week but down 3 with ball at midfield RB Abanikanda fumbled and the Heels final 2 td drives were 49 & 35 yds. We won a 3★ on these pages going against Cuse LW in their 41-24 (+1) loss to ND. The Orange lost QB Shradler to inj and finished w/a ssn low 286 yds. RB Tucker was held to 60 rush yds LW and faces a Pitt D that allows 120 rush ypg (3.8). Cuse's small Diene has been manhandled the L2W by Clem & ND allowing 293 & 246 rush. Pitt will use the same strategy and hand the Orange their 3rd straight loss.

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 2ND

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 8 over Central Michigan - Both are recent MAC Champs, NIU LY & CM in '19 but now the loser will have a losing ssn. LY this game decided the MAC West with 3 lead changes in 4Q as NIU kicked the GW FG w/54 left. Against 2 common foes (Ball St & UT), CM was outscored by 22 pts & outgained 72 yds, while NIU was outscored by 26 ppg but had 4 TO's vs UT as they actually outgained both with a comb 121 yds. CM has lost 4 straight ATS losses with 2 outright upset losses, with their only SU win in the stretch 28-21 at Akron as a 13 pt AF. NIU is on a 1-3 SU & ATS run with 2 outright upset losses but also had a 39-10 win over EM as a 3 pt AD. NIU has showed a bit more potential & are at home, so we will lean with them here.

BOWLING GREEN by 5 over Western Michigan - Favorite is 5-1 SU & 4-2 ATS in series. Both are tied for 2nd in their division races but while WM is 2-2 in MAC play they are 3-5 SU & ATS, while BG is 3-1 in MAC play & 4-4 SU & 3-4-1 ATS despite playing the tougher schedule (#73#105). Last met in '19 when WM won 49-10 as a 27' pt HF. Against Miami (only common foe). WM won 16-10 but was outgained 304-305 while BG won 17-13 with a 325-189 yd edge while WM has a slight Off edge (#101#103). BG has a good size Def edge (#79#95). We will lean with the home team with the better defense as they have won 3 of 4 and seem to have finally got on track.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 3RD

RICE by 3 over UTEP - UTEP ended a 3 game losing streak LY by beating Rice 38-28 (-9). Both teams are off disappointing losses. Rice was 15' pt home chalk against CLT but got buried after taking a 14-7 1Q lead in a 56-23 loss. UTEP is off a 24-13 (-2) home loss to Middle Tenn. The Miners are 1-3 SU/ATS and -27 ypg on the road but the win did come over the same CLT team that just blew out Rice. The Owls are 3-1 SU/ATS and +51 ypg at home despite last week's loss. Against 3 common foes Rice is 1-2 SU/0-3 ATS, -11.6 ppg & -26.6 ypg while UTEP is 2-1 SU/ATS, -0.3 ppg & +66 ypg. This game is crucial to both teams' bowl hopes and we give the home tm a fg edge.

Appalachian St by 6 over COASTAL CAROLINA - App St has won 4 of 5 mtgs SU and have covered 3 of the L/4. App St is off a gm vs an FCS foe while CC played at Marshall and won 24-13 despite being -136 yds (+2 TO). App St QB Brice (1921, 65%, 22-4) could have a big day here vs a CC pass DEF that ranks #120 & gives up 273 ypg (65%). App St did run for 404 (6.3) vs GSt 2 wks ago an CC's run D all'd 324 (10.5) to ODU but held MU LW to 87 (2.4). App St's pass rush has recorded 23 sks (10.6%) and CC has all'd 9 sks their L/2 gms. App St's run D has done well all ssn (133, 3.8) but their pass D ranks #119 and CC QB McCall is one of the most efficient QB's in FBS (2061, 69%, 19-1). CC enters 7-1 SU but are just 1-4 ATS at home TY and we think App St gets the win.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 4TH

Duke by 4 over BOSTON COLLEGE - Home tm in this series is 2-3 SU/0-5 ATS. BC opened with a 26-6 win over Duke in their L/mtg in '20. This is Duke's first trip to Chestnut Hill s/'11. Duke is fresh off a bye and needs 1 more win to be bowl elig in HC Elko's first year. HC Hafley's seat is getting hot after BC lost to UConn 13-3 (-7) with QB Jurkovec going out early w/inj (CS). All 5 ACC mtgs have gone 'Under' (avg just 31.8 ppg) and we expect another low scoring affair. Duke is just 2-11 ATS on the road and BC is 12-5 as a HD while pl'y'g a tougher sked (#42 vs #93).

CONNECTICUT by 17 over Massachusetts - Former 1-AA conf rivals, the favorite is 3-1 SU & ATS in FBS meetings but LY when they met, they were a combined 0-11 & UMass won 27-13 as a 3 pt HD finishing with a 407-191 yd edge. This year both have new HC's, but while UMass is just 1-7 SU & 3-5 ATS, UConn is 4-5 SU & 7-2 ATS covering 5 straight & winning 3 of L/4 incl LW's 13-3 upset of BC as a 7' pt HD. UMass is off a 23-13 loss to NMSU as a 1' pt HD. UConn has a slight edge on Off & a bigger one on D (#92#126) despite playing the tougher sked (#88#119). Huskies are 2-0 ATS as a HF beating Central Conn 28-3 (-20) & FIU 33-12 (-5) while UMass is just 1-3 ATS all as a DD AD. While coming off a big upset UConn is flirting with bowl-eligibility & should take care of UMass.

WASHINGTON by 3 over Oregon St - WAS return from bye following 3 road trips over a 4 week span that incl a 28-21 win over Cal 2 wks ago where they finished with 28-18 FD and 476-306 yd edges. OSU is also back in action after a bye as they look for a 4th consec win (42-9 win over Colo 2 wks ago, 26-17 FD & 472-290 yd edges). LY OSU ended a 9-game losing skid against WAS by overcoming a 24-17 deficit in the 4Q and connecting on a GW 24-yd FG as time expired. After going just 2-6 ATS as a HF the previous 2 ssns, UW has gone a solid 4-1 ATS in that role in '22. Something will have to give in this one however as OSU is 10-3 ATS when listed as an AD.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 5TH

Air Force by 3 over Army - Gm played in Arlington, TX. Army has owned this series of late, winning 4 of the L/5 gms both SU/ATS incl pulling outright upsets the L/2 years. Both tms come in off a bye and AF's last gm was a home loss vs Boise while Army beat ULM 48-24 (+133 yds). While it is option vs option here (AF avg'g 337 rush ypg, Army avg'g 334 rush ypg) AF has done better vs the run this ssn, holding tms to 126 ypg (4.2) while Army is allowing 212 rush ypg (5.4). We also expect a low-scoring game as the game has gone 'Under' the total 8 straight gms. We'll call for the underdog to keep this game close but will side with the better DEF to get the outright win.

Michigan by 23 over RUTGERS - MICH has won 7 str in the series, but RUT has covered 2 in a row & the home tm has covered 3 of 4. LY, the Scarlet Knights actually out'd MICH 352-275 in a tight 20-13 (+20) loss at The Big House. RUT is off a 31-0 (+14) loss at MIN, which moved them to 4-4 SU/ATS. The RUT Def has been solid all yr, all'g just 295 ypg, but the Off has struggled & has been held to 16 pts or less in 5 of their L/6 gms. MICH stayed undefeated (8-0, 4-4 ATS) with a 29-7 (-22) beatdown of in-state rival MSU. The Def continues to impress, all'g 250 ypg & just 12 ppg. MICH should cruise to a relatively easy win, but the line is over 3 tds & RUT is 3-1 ATS at home this year & we see this one right near that line.

NC STATE by 1 over Wake Forest - The home team has dominated this series, going 21-4 SU/20-5 ATS. WF has won 4 of the L/5 SU & ATS including LY when WF was outgained 482-406 but led most of the game and won 45-42 (-1'). NCSt started Jack Chambers at QB last week but it was true frosh MJ Morris who led the 'Pack to a come-from-behind win over VTech. NCSt trailed 21-3 3Q and Morris threw for 265 and 3 td's. QB Hartman threw 3 int's LW in WF's 48-21 loss at L'ville and faces NCSt's pass D which has allowed an 8-11 ratio (#10 in pass D). You can't go against the home team in this series and the 'Pack have a huge edge on D so they are the pick.

Florida St by 5 over MIAMI, FL - The visitor was 12-2 ATS from '06-'19 but the home team has won the last 2. LY FSU built a 20-7 1H lead but UM led 28-23 late 4Q and had the 'Noles 4th & 15 on final drive then FSU converted and got GW td with :26 left. The 'Noles are off a 41-16 (-23) win over GTech. The Jackets final td came on the final play of the gm and FSU finished w/642-264 yd & 31-16 FD edges. UM didn't get a td last week w/o QB Van Dyke but still won 14-12 (-3) in 4OT over UVA. The 'Canes were held to a ssn low 272 yds but they should have a much better offensive effort, especially if Van Dyke comes back so we like the home underdog in a rivalry to keep it close.

VIRGINIA TECH by 1 over Georgia Tech - LY VT settled for 4 fg's but still won 26-17 (-4). A lot of great trends here point to taking the Yellow Jackets. The underdog is 13-2 ATS with 10 upsets including 7 of the last 8. The home team is just 1-10 ATS and GT has won the last 3 in Blacksburg. The Under is also 11-2-1 in this series. VT has lost 5 straight and blew a 21-3 lead to NCSt but did cover as 13' pt dogs. VT finished with 293 yds and 10 FD's. GT scored on the last play of the game LW and lost 41-16 while allowing a ssn high 642 yds. VT is -38 ypg while GT is -117 ypg but only -58 ypg with QB Sims who has missed the L/2 and GT has pl'y'd the tougher sked (#14 vs #69). Neither offense inspires us but the angles all clearly point to the road underdog.

PURDUE by 1 over Iowa - PUR has covered 3 str in the series, with outright upsets the L2Y, incl a 24-7 (+11) road win over #2 ranked Iowa LY, which knocked them from the unbeaten ranks. PUR is off a bye & enter at 5-3 (3-5 ATS). They had won 4 str prior to a 35-24 (+1) loss at WISC 2 wks ago. PUR is avg'g 445 ypg, but has been plagued by TOs, as they have 12 giveaways in their L/5 gms. Iowa is off a 33-13 (-11) win over NW, which moved them to 4-4 SU/ATS. The Off continues to be putrid, avg just 16 ppg & 248 ypg, while the Def has been stellar, all'g just 16 ppg & 278 ypg. PUR has been TO prone & are just 7-12 ATS as a HF under Brohm, so we expect Iowa to keep this one within the line.

Penn St by 13 over INDIANA - IND has covered 3 of the L/4, incl a 36-35 (+6) outright upset over #8 PSU LTH in '20. IU is off a bye, but have lost 5 str & enter this one at 3-5 SU/ATS. The Off has struggled the L/4, avg'g just 284 ypg after avg'g 408 the 1st 4 gms. Penn St (6-2, 5-3 ATS) is off a 44-31 (+15) home loss to Ohio St in which they actually out'd the Buckeyes 482-452, but were -4 in TOs. The Nittany Lions are 1-4 ATS the week after Ohio St & just 9-23 ATS off a SU loss under Franklin, plus IND is off extra rest, so we'll side with the Hoosiers who are 2-0 ATS as a HD this year.

LOUISVILLE by 14 over James Madison - This is a tough ACC sandwich for the Cardinals who have Clemson on deck. JMU is off a bye after two straight losses and battling inj's including QB Centeio who missed their loss to Marshall prior to the bye. We won our 6th straight Underdog POW (2nd straight outright upset) on these pages last week with UL who beat WF 48-21 (+3)! JMU is +186 ypg while UL is +55 but UL has pl'y'd a tougher sked (#18 vs #127). UL has won & cov'd 3 straight and JMU lost their top S (#3 tk'l'r) and have inj's at QB, DL and OL so we have the Cardinals winning by DD's.

Oklahoma St by 9 over KANSAS - OSU has won 12 straight gms (8-2-2 ATS) against KU. The L/2 mtgs OSU has won by a comb'd score of 102-10 & outgained KU by 792 yds! KU is off a bye & had a chance to get healthier while OSU is dealing with their fair share of inj's to & lost 48-0 LW at KSt (-278 yds, -3 TO). Neither tm is playing well on DEF as OSU is allowing 502 ypg/36 ppg vs B12 foes while KU is allowing 481 ypg/36 ppg vs B12 foes. The difference here is KU's offense has dropped off with the loss of QB Daniels while OSU is putting up 436 ypg/39 ppg led by QB Sanders (2177, 58%, 15-4). OSU also has a big edge on ST's here (#3 vs #99). Despite the ugly loss last week, OSU is a well-coached tm & we think they bounce back with a win.

CINCINNATI by 17 over Navy - Navy held the #2 Bearcats to 271 tll yds in a 27-20 (+28) home loss LY. The Middies enter this one at 3-5 (4-4 ATS) & after their 27-20 (-13') home OT win over Temple. Navy led 13-3 at HT, but all'd a tying FG with 1:08 left & were actually out'd 288-242 & all of the Middies yds came on the ground. CIN is off a 25-21 (+1) loss at UCF which moved them to 6-2 & they have failed to cover in 4 straight. CIN has won 30 str home gms dating back to 2017 & while we don't foresee a Navy win here, we do think they can keep this one a little closer than expected.

Usf by 5 over TEMPLE - Tms have met every yr s/'15 & USF is 5-2 ATS (3-4 SU) in those matchups. The Bulls have lost 6 str after a 42-27 (+17) loss at HOU & have still not beaten an FBS foe TY. The USF Def has been shredded all yr to the tune of 38 ppg & 488 ypg, incl 206 ypg on the ground. Temple is off a 27-20 (+13) OT loss at Navy, in which they actually had a 288-224 ydg edge. The Def has been effective getting after the QB, with 29 sks, but is all'g 185 rush ypg, while the Off is avg'g just 284 ypg (15 ppg). This is the 1st time USF has been favored vs an FBS foe since 2020 & Temple is 4-0 ATS at home TY, but we see this one right near the line.

Minnesota by 6 over NEBRASKA - MIN has won & covered 3 str in series, incl a 30-23 (+4) home upset win LY. MIN ended their 3 gm losing streak with a 31-0 (-14) home win over RUT. After all'g 475 ypg the prvs 2 gms, MIN held RUT to just 134 tll yds & are now all'g only 14 ppg TY. The Off has struggled the L/4 wks, as they've avg'd just 300 ypg. The 3-5 Huskers (2-6 ATS) are off a 26-9 (+7) home loss to ILL in which they were out'd 367-248 & all'd 188 rush yds. NEB lost starting QB Thompson in the 2Q & his status for this one is ?. MIN has failed to cover their L/2 on the road, so we'll side with a desperate NEB squad that has been more competitive since their coaching change.



UNDERDOG PLAY OF THE WEEK

Over 40 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! We've won 6 straight on this play. Upright upsets have been a major theme in recent years including two straight with Louisville beating Wake Forest 41-17 LW! Here is This week's Underdog Play:

TULSA (+7) over Tulane

TULSA over Tulane- Tulsa has won the L/2 mtgs, incl a 20-13 (+3) win at Tulane LY, in which they out'd the Green Wave 382-308. The Hurricane come in at 3-5 SU/ATS after their 45-34 (+2) home loss to SMU, but have run for over 180 yds (5.8 ypc) in B2B gms. Tulane comes in off a bye & finds themselves ranked (#23) for the 1st time since 1998! Tulane won't overwhelm on either side of the ball, as they are avg 12 yds less than opps avg (#86) & holding opps to 38 yds under avg (#46), but they are +7 in TO margin in their L/3 gms. Tulane has the extra rest, but Tulsa is 5-2 ATS (2-1 TY) as a HD s/18 & we think an outright upset at home is a distinct possibility so we go back to the Golden Hurricane who has already won twice as our Underdog POW! **FORECAST: TULSA by 3**

Middle Tennessee by 10 over LOUISIANA TECH - These two last met in '16 and the home team has won all 3 previous mtgs. LT has lost 3 straight including LW at FIU 42-34 (-6) in OT. QB Landry Lyddy made his first career start with their top 2 QB's out w/inj. MT was off 3 straight losses LW and beat UTEP 24-13 on the road. QB Cunningham has a 13-5 ratio and faces an LT D that just allowed FIU to throw for 321. The Bulldogs D is allowing foes to put up 119 ypg more than their avg (#130 in FBS). MT's 3 CUSA losses are to the top of the conference (UTSA/UAB/WKU) while NT has losses to Rice and FIU and every MT game has been decided by DD's.

Ucla by 5 over ARIZONA ST - Following their 1st loss of the ssn 2 weeks ago, UCLA got back into the win column LW against Stanford with RB Charbonnet running for 198 yds, 3 TD's. UCLA now heads into Tempe to take on ASU, who has won 2 of their L/3 after an 8 pt win LW in Boulder where QB Bourguet threw for 435 yds. In a series that's seen 5 outright upsets since '15, ASU (+3) went into Pasadena LY and scored 18 unanswered 2H points in their 2nd largest road win over a ranked foe in school history. UCLA has been an AF just 4 times in 5 years under HC Kelly going 3-1 ATS. ASU however is on a 14-6 ATS run as a dog and have played much better in the past month under interim HC Aguano.

TEXAS A&M by 3 over Florida - A&M is 2-1 SU/ATS in series mtgs. FL fell behind 21-0 LW vs UGA but did get within 8 3Q and covered, losing 42-20 (+23). A&M suffered their 4th straight loss, falling 31-28 (+2) at home against Ole Miss. Frosh QB Weigman had his first career start and threw for 338 and 4 td's as A&M put up a ssn high vs FBS foes, 480 yds. A&M's D allowed a ssn high 530 yds and 390 rush. They are giving up 206 (4.8) on the ssn and FL is rushing for 199 (6.4). Expect the Gators to keep this closer than expected as Napier is now 14-3-1 as a dog and A&M is 2-5-1 ATS this ssn.

SMU by 3 over Houston - The home tm has won 4 of 5 in the series & has covered 5 straight. SMU has lost 4 of 6 entering this one, but is off a 45-34 (-2) win at Tulsa LW. SMU ply'd w/o starting QB Mordecai, but should return here. Bkp Stone (rFR, PS#12) made his 1st career start & went 11-17 for 219 yds with a 1-0 ratio, but left inj'd in 2Q, so the Mustangs finished with their 3rd string QB Jennings. The SMU DEF all'd 398 tt yds & is now all'g 30 ppg & 421 ypg TY, incl 202 rush ypg. HOU is off a 42-27 (-17) win over hapless USF & are on a 3 gm win streak. Both tms have played at least 4 gms that have been decided by 8 pts or less & we see another close game unfolding in this one.

Troy by 3 over LOUISIANA - LA has won 6 of the L/8 (5-2-1 ATS) incl winning & covering the L/2. Troy last played 16 days ago at SAIA and won a DEF slugfest 10-6, holding SAIA to 216 yds below their ssn avg. LA is also off extra rest after playing last Thur at SMiss where they were +100 yds but -2 TO's and lost 39-24. Troy has a super DEF as they are holding SBC foes to 275 ypg/14 ppg & overall are holding their foes to 101 ypg under their ssn avg (#9). LA's DEF has been good the L/4 gms, holding tms to 312 ypg/23 ppg and Troy's offense has been decent, avg'g just 358 ypg/20 ppg vs SBC foes. Troy also has the sked edge (#68/#107) with 2 good DEF's here we think this will be a lower scoring game and will side the more consistent Troy team to get a close road win.

SOUTHERN MISS by 9 over Georgia St - First mtg. SMiss has won 4 of their L/5 gms after taking down LA last Thur 39-24 (-100 yds, +2 TO) and are in the hunt for the SBC West crown. GST is off a 31-17 win vs ODU (+130 yds). GST has gotten great production from their run gm (232, 4.8) but here face a SMiss DEF that is all'g just 327 ypg the L/4 gms incl just 54 rush ypg (1.6). The SMiss pass rush has been strong all ssn as they have 29 sks. SMiss's offense is only avg'g 302 ypg vs SBC foes but they take on a GST DEF that is all'g 435 ypg/33 ppg vs SBC foes. SMiss is +64 ypg at home TY while GST overall in SBC play is -49 ypg. SMiss is 6-2 ATS TY and appears to be getting stronger as the ssn moves along & at home we like them to get the win by over a td.

South Carolina by 5 over VANDERBILT - SC is 13-0 SU in this series and 14-2 SU in Nashville and cov'd 6 str from '15-20 but did only win LY 21-20 (-18). The Gamecocks were upset 23-10 as 3' pt HF last week by MO. SC put up a ssn low 203 yds and QB Rattler still has just 5 td passes all ssn. Vandy is off a bye and lost to that same Mizzou team 17-14 (+14) on the road. QB Swann was inj'd but bkp Wright led 2 wins earlier TY and is a dual threat. The 'Dores have lost 25 straight vs SEC foes (11-14 ATS) but SC is 1-5 SU/ATS on the SEC road under Beamer. We think Vandy keeps it closer than expected.

GEORGIA by 6 over Tennessee - First time these 2 meet both in the top 10 since '05. Tenn made a statement LW in their 44-6 (-11) win over KY. The 'Cats had allowed 4 td passes all ssn but QB Hooker threw for 3 and WR Hyatt had another huge gm (5-138) and has broken Tenn's single ssn rec rd record (Marcus Nash). UGA's D is allowing just 263 ypg and holding foes 140 ypg below their avg (#1 in FBS) but the Vols Off avg 162 ypg more than their foes allow (also #1 in FBS). UGA has just 10 sks TY but did get 3 LW. UGA allows 202 rush ypg (5.7) but Tenn allows just 93 (2.9). Tenn has a win at LSU already so the atmosphere won't be too much but we will take the better D to win by under a td.

TCU by 12 over Texas Tech - TCU has won 3 straight vs TT and have covered the L/2. TCU stayed unbeaten with a 41-31 win at WV while TT lost at home 45-17 vs Baylor (-134 yds, -4 TO). TT has all'd 4 of 5 B12 foes to gain over 430 yds and TCU is avg'g 524 ypg/43 ppg vs B12 foes. TT does have the #36 pass D but take on QB Duggan (2212, 67%, 22-2). TT QB Morton LW was 11-34 with 3 int's & he may lose the job to a returning QB Shough. TT is 0-3 SU/ATS and are -7 TO's in 3 road gms. At home vs B12 foes TCU is 3-0/2-1 ATS & are +181 ypg/+14 ppg, but in 2 of those gms they were down by 17 pts 1H and came back 2H to win. We'll lean slightly with TCU as they are 6-1-1 ATS TY.

MEMPHIS by 1 over Ucf - UCF is 15-1 in series, but MEM has cov'd 2 of 3 & there have been outright upsets each of the L/2Y. UCF comes in off a 25-21 (-1) home win against CIN, which FINALLY delivered a Power Sweep 4★ winner! The Knights are now 6-2 (5-3 ATS). QB Plumlee did suffer a concussion mid-2Q & his status for this one is in question. MEM is off a bye, having lost 3 straight by a tt of 13 pts with a -6 TO margin. The Tigers come in gaining 34 more ypg than their opps allow (#49), but are all'g 14 ypg more than their opps avg (#87). UCF is just 6-10 ATS as an AF since 2019, while MEM is 4-0 ATS as a HD the L/2Y, so we are calling for a MEM win & the 3rd str outright upset in the series.

UTAH ST by 10 over New Mexico - USU has won and covered the L/5 vs NMex. Both tms enter here off a bye. USU is dealing with inj issues at the QB position as 4th string QB Davenport started the last gm at WY 2 wks ago, but Cooper Legas could be ready to go here (CS). As for NMex their offense is struggling as they are only avg'g 219 ypg/14 ppg vs MW foes. NMex has been carried by their DEF all ssn (340 ypg all'd) but in their last gm struggled & gave up 510 yds to Fresno. Depending on the QB situation USU may not be much of an offensive threat, but we'll still take the Aggies

UAB by 7 over Utsa - UAB is out for revenge after losing LY 34-31, giving up a td w/:04 left when QB Harris picked up a bad snap and lobbed it into EZ for the GW td. UAB has won all 4 home gms TY but lost all 4 road gms incl LW at FAU 24-17. QB Hopkins was out so bkp Jacob Zeno got his first start and threw for 192. Utsa is off a much needed bye after winning 5 straight but failed to cover their L/3 and are dealing with multiple inj's on the OL and DL. UAB is +28 ppg and +167 ypg at home. Utsa held NT to 22 rush yds prior to their bye but face CUSA's top RB in McBride (1143, 7.0) who has topped 100 yds in every gm TY. UAB is 21-8-2 ATS at home so we will call for the Blazers to get revenge.

Alabama by 9 over LSU - Bama has won 9 of the L/10 mtgs and have won the last 5 in Baton Rouge (4-1 ATS). LY LSU was +28' but held Bama to a ssn low 308 yds and only lost 20-14. Both tms are fresh off a bye. Bama is 2-5 ATS in true road games since LY with 5 gms being decided by 7 or less (2 losses). LSU is now 6-2 SU/ATS and beat Ole Miss 45-20 (-1) prior to their bye. QB Daniels has a 12-1 ratio and faces a Tide D that allowed Tenn to throw for 455 on the road. Bama does have edges in all 3 phases including ST's (#24 vs #116). Saban had Brian Kelly's number while he was at Notre Dame but Kelly is 14-6-1 as a home dog in his career so we give the Tigers a slight lean.

NORTH TEXAS by 14 over Fiu - FIU has lost the last two meetings but only by a fg LTH in '14 and won in Denton back in '08 & '10. The Panthers are flirting with bowl elig after beating LA Tech 42-34 (+6) last week. They've covered 4 of their L/5 and they've put up 379 ypg over that span. WR Chambers returned from inj 2 games ago and is 17-224 in the L/2. NT only led WKU 20-13 3Q LW but pulled away and won by 27, putting on the most yds of the 'Toppers have allowed all ssn (541). FIU is an improving team and NT has a huge game vs UAB on deck so we think the Panthers put up a strong fight.

South Alabama by 6 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - SAIA is just 1-7 SU/2-6 ATS vs GS as SBC foes but that lone win came last season 41-14. GS comes in off a bye and are 5-3 this ssn led by a tremendous pass offense (353 ypg vs SBC foes) but here they take on a SAIA DEF that is holding SBC foes to 285 ypg/16 ppg and LW gave up just 158 yds to Ark St incl -19 rush yds where we won a 3★ LP play on Under 53! GS has incredibly all'd just 2 sacks all ssn but do face a SAIA pass rush that has 11 sks the L/3 gms. SAIA does also have the #31 pass D and they hold foes to 85 rush ypg (2.8). GS's DEF struggles as they allow SBC foes to gain 536 ypg/34 ppg so SAIA's offense could have a big day. We like the SAIA D to limit GS's offense and get the win.

ULM by 1 over Texas St - ULM has failed to cover 6 of the L/8 gms vs TXSt and have lost the L/2 vs TXSt both SU/ATS. Both tms are off a bye here and ULM comes in having lost 4 straight gms but had 2 SBC losses to Coastal & SAIA by 7 pts each. TXSt has won just 1 of their L/4 gms but that win was a home upset of App St. ULM has struggled on DEF the L/4 gms (471 ypg/41 ppg) but here face a TXSt offense that has avg'd just 279 ypg the L/4 gms. ULM's offense has shown life against some good tms incl 438 vs SAIA & TXSt's D allows 408 ypg vs SBC foes. All 6 of ULM's wins the L/2Y are at home & we see them getting the narrow win here.

SAN DIEGO ST by 7 over Unlv - SDSSt has won 10 of the L/12 gms SU but more recently have only covered 1 of the L/4 mtgs. UNLV has a chance to get healthy (QB Brumfield, RB Robbins DNP last gm, check status) LW with a bye week while SDSSt gave up 2 td's in the final 90 seconds to Fresno & lost 32-28 (+58 yds, -3 TO's). SDSSt did get a good performance from QB Mayden LW (291, 79%, 2 td) and he faces the #83 pass D here. If UNLV is able to get their QB and RB back this week they should be able to keep this game close as SDSSt only beat Hawaii by 2 pts at home a few wks ago and while UNLV's L/3 gms w/o Brumfield have been rough on offense (230 ypg/12 ppg) but they avg'd 423 ypg/38 ppg with him as the QB & can hang around if he's back.

NOTRE DAME by 1 over Clemson - ND puts their 26 game reg ssn win streak over ACC foes on the line. In '20 these 2 split with ND winning in the reg ssn when DJU made his 1st road start and threw for 439. Since the Irish started 0-2 they've won 5 of their L/6 including a 41-24 (+1) win at Cuse LW. Clem is fresh off a bye and only beat Cuse 27-21 at home prior, but did have a 450-291 yd edge (-3 TO's). QB Pyne has a 13-4 ratio since taking over and ND has faced a much tougher sked (#11 vs #61). ND is 0-4 ATS at home TY but all as chalk and now they are the dog. These two teams are very even on paper but we will take the home Irish to win a close game.

TUESDAY NOVEMBER 8TH

Eastern Michigan by 6 over AKRON - LW we won a 3★ Late Phone Selection on EM as they easily covered vs Toledo as a 6' pt HF, but heartbreakingly with first place in the MAC West on the line, they never trailed until giving up the GW td w/2:09 left to lose 27-24. A win here would make them bowl eligible for a 5th time in L/7 yrs. LW Akron never led vs Miami losing 27-9 as a 9 pt HD but finished with a 20-13 FD & 396-268 yd edges but were on the wrong end of a 3-0 TO edge. Still while Akron has lost 8 straight they are on a 4-2 ATS run & EM is just 2-2 AU & 0-4 ATS as a FAV TY.

MIAMI, OH by 3 over Ohio - "Battle of the Bricks", the underdog has 3 straight outright upsets in this rivalry & Ohio is on a 12-3 run (9-5-1 ATS). Miami has 3 extra days of rest here after beating Akron 27-9 (-9). Ohio will be off a Tues showdown with Buffalo for the lead in the MAC East but even with a loss will still be in the hunt, while Miami with 3 MAC losses would need a lot of dominoes to fall their way. While Ohio has Off edge (#98-#117), this will be the 3rd straight start for MU's QB Gabbert, who missed the previous 7 gms with injury. Miami has a big Def edge (#57-#116) & should get the win here.

TOLEDO by 7 over Ball St - Toledo is 8-4 SU in series but just 5-7 ATS. UT has edges on both Off (#81-#107) & Def (#54-#96). While Ball St ply'd KSU the previous Tues, the Rockets will have a couple of extra days of rest after coming from behind to beat EM 27-24 (-6) with their GW td w/2:09 left giving them the first lead. GT transfer QB Gleason started in place of QB Finn, who missed game with inj. UT finished with a 374-217 yd edge. Ball St had lost to EM the week prior 20-16 being outgained 359-292. We look for their extra time to either get Finn healthy & UT should take care of business here.

After dropping 5 straight to the Packers by 10 ppg, the Lions (+3) picked up a 37-30 win in LY's ssn finale as GB pulled their starters early having already clinching a playoff berth. While DET is 6-2 ATS inside the DIV, we're leaning with the visitor here as they've covered 13 of their past 20 against the NFC North and are shockingly on a 4-game losing skid!

3★ Seattle over ARIZONA - The Cardinals are in Glendale for the only time in a 4-week span following an 8 pt loss LW in MIN (QB Murray 362 tl yds, 2 key int's) and road trips to LA and Mexico City where they take on the 49ers on deck. The Seahawks head into the desert sitting on a 3-game winning streak (all'd just 14 FD's & 225 yds in a 27-13 victory over the Giants) that started with a 19-9 (+2) home win a few weeks back against this same ARZ squad. With the Cardinals struggling in the home chalk role in recent years with just a 5-13 ATS mark, we're giving the Seahawks (trip to Germany on deck) the outright win here as they've gone 8-3 ATS when listed as a DIV AD.

2★ ATLANTA over La Chargers - The Chargers return to action after their bye week to take on a Falcons squad that's at home for a 2nd consecutive week following an OT win over DIV rival CAR where they moved to atop the NFC South standings (CAR 478-406 yd edge). After winning 8 of their first 9 matchups in this series, the Falcons have now dropped 2 straight to the Chargers including a 20-17 road loss in '20. While this is also a sandwich game for ATL with another bout against the Panthers on deck, they have turned around LY's HD struggles (0-4 ATS) with a perfect 3-0 ATS mark in that role for '22 that includes outright upsets of CLE and SF.

OTHER PLAYS

Philadelphia at HOUSTON - Thursday - The Eagles remained undefeated on the year following a 22 pt home victory over in-state rival PIT with QB Hurts throwing for 285 yds and 4 TD's. HOU meanwhile was held to just 10 FD's and 161 yds in a 17-10 defeat against the Titans. The Texans have NEVER beaten the Eagles in their franchise history with PHI picking up 5 wins by 11 ppg. While PHI is just 3-7 ATS in recent contests as away chalk, the Texans have struggled against NFC foes with just a 1-7-2 ATS mark.

We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

NEW ENGLAND by 3 over Indianapolis - Following an embarrassing home matchup against the Bears where they allowed one of the league's worst offenses to put up 33 pts and nearly 400 yds, the Patriots picked up a 5 pt road win LW at the Jets (3★ LP Winner on Under 40!) despite a 387-288 yd disadvantage. NE now returns to Foxboro to take on a Colts squad that saw the Commanders get the comeback victory (GW TD w/:26 left) in the 1st career start for QB Sam Ehlinger (17-23-201-0-0, 15 rush yds). LY the Colts (-2) FINALLY ended their 8-game losing skid to the Patriots by picking up a 27-17 victory despite NE finishing with 20-15 FD and 365-275 yd edges. With IND a solid 6-2 ATS an an AD coming in and the Patriots struggling in recent matchups against running QB's such as Justin Fields, Lamar Jackson and Josh Allen, we expect the Colts to stay within the line in this one.

Buffalo by 14 over NY JETS - The Bills had no issue disposing of the struggling Packers a week ago at home as they led 24-7 at HT in the eventual 10 pt victory. They now head to East Rutherford to take on a Jets team that saw their 4-game winning streak snapped LW against the Patriots thanks in part to 3 int's by QB Wilson. The Bills have picked up the series sweep in each of the past 2 years. In their trip here a year ago, BUF (-13) finished with a 489-366 yd edge en route to a 45-17 victory. While the Jets have earned some solid wins throughout the '22 ssn along with 7 covers in the past 11 as a dog, the Bills are 7-2 ATS in AFC East matchups and have showed no signs of slowing down.

CHICAGO by 1 over Miami - After an impressive MNF win in Foxboro against the Patriots, the Bears put forth a struggling effort in DAL where they allowed 49 pts and 442 yds and now return to Soldier Field to take on a Dolphins team that's riding a 2-game winning streak following a 4 pt win in Ford Field against the Lions (3★ LP Winner on MIA!) where QB Tagovailoa threw for 382 yds and 3 TD's. The Dolphins have collected victories in 4 of their last 5 meetings against the Bears including a 31-28 (+6) OT win back in South Beach in '18. However, with MIA currently on a 1-4 ATS run coming in and CHI's 7-1-1 ATS mark against AFC foes, we're giving the home team an excellent shot of grabbing an outright upset.

Minnesota by 1 over WASHINGTON - This marks the only HG in a 4-week span for the Commanders who return to D.C. following a comeback win in IND (GW TD w/:26 left). The Vikings meanwhile picked up an 8 pt home win over the Cardinals in their return from a bye thanks in part to a pair of late TO's by ARZ. MIN has won 4 of the last 5 meetings against the Commanders including a 19-9 (-16) home win in '19 where they had 22-14 FD and 434-216 yd edges. While the Commanders are just 6-11 ATS, we'll call for them to stay within the line as the Vikings have covered just 2 of their L/6 coming in and bkp QB Heinicke is now 2-0 as a starter.

CINCINNATI by 13 over Carolina - The Bengals are back at home on short rest following a MNF trip North to take on DIV rival CLE. The Panthers meanwhile are in a sandwich situation with an OT loss LW in ATL (RB Foreman 118 rush yds & 3 TD's) and a home matchup against the Falcons on deck. In their last meeting back in '18, the Panthers (-2) picked up a 31-21 victory thanks in part to a 4-0 TO edge. With CAR on just a 3-12 ATS run overall along with a 3-6 ATS mark as an AD, we're leaning with a Bengals squad that's covered 5 straight as of presstime.

Las Vegas by 3 over JACKSONVILLE - This is a rare situation for the Jaguars as they take on the Raiders TW in JAX following a trip to London where the Broncos got the GW TD w/1:47 remaining (teams usually have a bye week after a visit to the UK!).
