4★ UCF over Navy - Navy has covered 2 of the L/3 vs UCF, incl a 34-30 (+16) outright upset win LY, in which they rushed for 348 yds (4.8 ypc). The Middies (are off a 35-32 (+15) loss to Notre Dame in Baltimore. The Middies trailed 35-13 at HT, then outscored the Irish 19-0 in 2H, but failed to recover an onside kick with just over a minute left. UCF is off a 38-31 (+1) upset win at Tulane, which put the Knights in control of their own destiny for an AAC Title Gm berth. UCF QB Plumlee returned after missing LW & rushed for 176 yds (9.8 ypc) & 2 tds, as the Knights gained 351 (6.2) on the ground. Navy is 4-0 ATS in true road gms, but UCF has covered 3 str at home, so we like the Knights to win by over 3 tds. We've only won two 4★'s on these pages and both were on UCF so naturally we are going back to the Knights!

FORECAST: UCF by 28

3★ Florida over VANDERBILT - UF is 15-0 SU (9-6 ATS) traveling to Nashville and has cov'd 4 of the L/5 mtgs vs Vandy including a 42-0 win LY. The Gators chomped SC last week 38-6 (-8) and finished w/a 515-237 yd edge, giving us a 3★ winner on these pages and a 4★ LPS winner. Vandy is off an upset win at KY 24-21 (+17) where they held a 448-322 yd edge and held QB Levist to 109 pass yds. HC Napier has FL rushing for 226 ypg (6.1) and LW both RB's Johnson & Etienne topped 100 yds. Vandy is allowing 180 (5.2) rush in SEC play. Against 4 common foes, FL is 2-2 SU/ATS, +2 ppg & +7 ypg while Vandy is 1-3 SU/3-1 ATS but -17 ppg & -88 ypg. We've won our GOY going against Vandy twice, in 1988 & 2010 and won both!

FORECAST: Florida by 24

3★ Texas over KANSAS - Texas is out for revenge after KU went there LY and pulled the upset 57-56 in OT (Texas 31-pt chalk). UT is off a home loss to TCU where they were held to 199 yds & 10 pts. KU's run DEF will be in for a long day, as they are all'g 297 ypg (5.8) in their L/4 gms and here face B.Robinson (1158, 5.7, 12 td) who will want to have a big gm here after being held to 29 yds LW. KU also has the #106 pass D & are all'g 281 ypg (67%) in B12 play. UT's DEF has held foes to 67 ypg under their ssn avg, and last week held TCU to 226 yds under their ssn avg. KU runs well (210, 6.0) but UT stops the run (126, 3.3 vs B12 foes). UT also has the sked edge (#2 vs #38) & a large ST edge (#1 vs #101). We see UT getting revenge & winning by over 2 td's.

FORECAST: Texas by 17

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ NOTRE DAME over Boston College - ND is 8-0 SU vs BC and has covered the L/3, all as double-digit chalk, though this is the largest line in this series since 2011. Our last two 5★ GOY winners were both on the Irish including LY when they cruised to a 28-3 (-6) win over Virginia. Drew Pyne threw for 4 td's and ND held off Navy's upset bid LW in a 35-32 win. The Eagles pulled an upset of their own LW, beating NCSt 21-20 and bkp QB Moorhead threw for over 300 yds for the 2nd straight gm. The Irish are 4-1 ATS when they rush for more than 200 yds while BC has allowed over 200 rush in each of their L/2. ND has won their last 27 reg ssn gms vs ACC foes, and handed Clemson & NCar their only loss of the ssn this year (3-0 SU/ATS vs ACC TY)! BC lost to that same Clemson team by 28 earlier TY. We think the Irish keep their momentum and there is no doubt we have ND in the mix for this year's Game of the Year!

FORECAST: NOTRE DAME by 31

2★ PITTSBURGH over Duke - Pitt is 6-0 SU/ATS in this series and have put up over 600 yds in 2 of the L/3 mtgs including LY when the Panthers led 44-29 4Q and added a garbage time td and a frontdoor cover. Pitt avg 280 rush ypg in the L/7 vs Duke. Pitt's D pretty much won the game in the first 5 seconds last wk at UVA with B2B pick 6's on UVA's first 2 plays. The Panthers have allowed 145 & 144 yds in their L/2 and held UVA to -8 rush yds in a 37-7 (-5) win. Duke enters off a 24-7 (-9) win over VTech. The Blue Devils are 7-3 ATS but all 3 losses came on the road where they are -51 ypg. Pitt has a huge edge on D, holding foes 79 ypg below their avg. Pitt is +91 ypg while Duke is +37 ypg but Pitt has ply'd a tougher sked (#61 vs #92). We will go with the stronger D at home to win by over 2 touchdowns.

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 16TH

KENT ST by 3 over Eastern Michigan - Kent St has won 6 of L/7 mtg going 5-2 ATS. Last met in '20, when KS came from behind to win 27-23 but failed to cover as a 4' pt HF. While EM is already bowl eligible, KS need to win here & next week to be eligible. LW EM led Akron 31-14 into 4Q but were just up 31-28 w/12:55 left. They won 34-28 but failed to cover as a 7 pt AF. LW Kent St cruised to a 40-6 win over BG as a 2' pt AD ending a streak of 5 straight ATS losses. Against 3 common foes EM is 2-1 SU & ATS (+2.3 ppg) while KS is 1-2 SU & 0-3 ATS (-7.3 ppg). While KS may win EM is 4-1 ATS as a dog TY incl 3 outright upsets, so we will take the Eagles & the pts.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 6 over Western Michigan - These rivals play for the Victory Cannon Trophy. LY CM ended a 3 game series losing streak 42-30 as a 9 pt AD. LW in a game that had 7 lead changes WM led NIU 21-17 into 4Q but allowed a GW td w/:56 left to lose 24-21 (even). LW CM trailed UB 24-7 at HT but inserted true frosh QB Bert Emanuel, who rushed for 75 & 87 yd td's in 3Q & ran for the GW yd with 7:29 left as CM held on for a 31-27 win as a 2' pt HF. Against 3 common foes both are 1-2 SU but WM is 2-1 ATS (even) while CM is 1-2 ATS (-1.3 ppg). The Visitor in this rivalry is 7-2 SU & 9-0 ATS and so we will take WM, who has opened as a DD dog

Miami, OH by 1 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - Last met in '19 when NIU could not hold onto a 17-14 3Q lead losing 27-24 as a 2' pt AF. LW NIU true frosh QB threw 3 INT's but NIU on the legs or QB Lynch (83 yd rush) won 24-21 (even), when Lynch rushed for the GW td with :56 left. Both had been expected to compete for their Divisional Crowns but both are out the races & in fact Miami needs to win out to be bowl eligible, while LY's MAC Champ NIU is already locked into a losing season. MU is 0-2 SU & ATS vs common foes losing 16-10 to WM as a 6' pt HF & losing 37-21 to Ohio as a 2' pt HD. NIU is 1-1 SU & ATD losing to Ohio 24-17 as a 3 pt AF & beating WM 24-21 (even). This should be a very close game which & while NIU is 7-3 SU vs Miami they are just 1-7 ATS since 2006, so we will take Miami & the points here.

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 17TH

TULANE at Smu - SMU has won 7 straight in the series (5-2 ATS), but the home team has covered 3 in a row. LY #22 ranked SMU throttled Tulane 55-26 (-14), as they put up 612 yds of tll offense. SMU (6-4, 5-5 ATS) is off a 41-23 (-17) win at USF, which clinched a bowl for the Mustangs. SMU offense has hit it's stride the L2W under 1st yr HC Lashlee, as they are avg'g 59 ppg & 598 ypg the L2W. Tulane (8-2 SU/ATS) suffered their 1st AAC loss LW, a 38-31 (-1) home defeat to UCF, which ended their 5 gm win streak. SMU is on a 4-0 ATS run & Tulane has a matchup with CIN for a potential AAC Title Gm on deck. Call 1-800-654-3448 or goto NCSports.com and get our Thursday Night College Marquee.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 18TH

TULSA by 13 over Usf - Tulsa has won the L/2 mtgs, but USF did cover LY in a 32-31 (+8) home loss, despite being outg'd 550-268. USF (1-9, 3-7 ATS) is off a 41-23 (+17) home loss to SMU, in their 1st gm since firing HC Scott after a 4-26 record in 2+ ssn's. The Bulls Def is all'g 43 ppg & 537 ypg in the L/7. Tulsa's faint bowl hopes were dashed LW, in a 26-10 (+6) loss at MEM that moved them to 3-7 SU/ATS. Tulsa has been unable to protect the QB, as they've all'd 32 sks the L6W. Tulsa is in the midst of an 0-5 ATS run, while USF is on their own 1-3 ATS run & our number is right near the opening line, so we don't have a strong lean here.

San Diego St by 12 over NEW MEXICO - SDSt has won 8 straight mtgs & have covered 3 of the L/4 mtgs. SDSt's offense has improved since QB Mayden took over, avg'g 385 ypg the L/5 gms, but here take on a NMex DEF that is all'g 347 ypg & if you take out the LSU & Fresno gms they are only all'g 290 ypg. NMex will need strong play from their DEF as their offense is getting held to 140 ypg less than their foes allow (#131) and SDSt is giving up just 292 ypg the L/4 gms. SDSt has just 2 wins over FBS tms this ssn by DD's and against 3 common MW foes SDSt is -96 ypg while NMex is -209 ypg. We see NMex's stingy DEF keeping them within the line & keep in mind NMex DC Rocky Long is the former HC at SDSt & will surely have his DEF fired up for this one.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 19TH

IOWA ST by 7 over Texas Tech - ISU had their 5 gm SU/ATS win streak snapped LY vs TT on a GW FG. ISU's DEF has been strong all ssn, holding tms to 149 ypg under their ssn avg (#2) but LW ISU was done in by 5 TO's vs OSU as they were +89 yds. While ISU only has 15 sks TY the TT OL has all'd 22 sks the L/6 gms. TT also has issues with TO's on the road as they are -8 TO's on the road TY & have thrown 6 int's the L/3 gms. TT's DEF on the other hand has all'd 420+ yds in all but 1 B12 gm this ssn & LW vs KU gave up 525 yds. ISU's offense is improving (375 ypg L/4 gms). ISU is 6-3 ATS the L3Y as a HF and we will side with the stronger DEF by a TD.

Kansas St by 9 over WEST VIRGINIA - LY KSt snapped a 4 gm SU/ATS losing skid to WVU. WVU is off an upset win over OU snapping a 4 gm SU/ATS losing skid. KSt is off a 31-3 win at BU where bkp QB Howard came in & threw for 3 td's. WVU's defense has been an issue all ssn as they are all'g 480 ypg vs B12 foes. Their struggles have come vs the pass as they have the #113 pass D & give up 297 pass ypg vs B12 tms. KSt's offense is more of a rush-based attack (215, 5.3) but they have avg'd 267 pass ypg the L/5 gms. KSt's DEF has had their issues at times (4 gms of 450+ yds all'd) but overall are holding B12 foes to 59 ypg under their ssn avg & are +11 TO's TY. The WVU offense has avg'd just 376 ypg vs B12 foes. Against common foes KSt is +9 ypg while WVU is -135 ypg. Despite win LW, WVU is still 4-6 and face a much more disciplined KSt tm.

FLORIDA ST by 28 over Louisiana - First meeting. FSU closed out ACC play LW with a 38-3 win at Cuse (+260 yds) & over their L/3 gms are +301 ypg/+34 ppg. LA got back in the win column last Thur with a win over GSthrn but needs 1 more win for a bowl. LA QB Woolridge did have to leave LW's gm but came back (check status) but they face a DEF that is all'g just 204 ypg/7 ppg the L/3 gms. The Cajuns have a solid rush DEF (124, 3.6) but take on an FSU rush attack avg'g 223 ypg (5.9) the L/5 gms. While this is a big look ahead spot for FSU, they are rolling right now & don't want to lose momentum so we'll take FSU by 4 td's.

Penn St by 24 over RUTGERS - Penn St has won all 8 gms in Big10 play & Rutgers has only scored a total of 29 pts (3.6 ppg) in those mtgs. The Scarlet Knights were shutout 28-0 (+17) at PSU LY, in which they were held to just 160 tll yds. Rutgers' (4-6, x-x ATS) bowl hopes took a hit LW, as they lost 27-21 (+10) at Mich St to move to 1-6 in B10 play. RfR QB Wimsatt made his 3rd consec start & threw 3 tds, but now has a just 4-6 ratio TY. PSU is off a 30-0 (-10) home win over Maryland, which delivered a 3★ LPS winner LW! Penn St enters this one with our # Pass Eff Def, which has forced 10 ints & the Nittany Lions have covered in 4 straight, so this could be another blowout loss in the series for Rutgers.

Tennessee by 31 over SOUTH CAROLINA - Tenn has won the L/3 mtgs including LY when they jumped to a 38-7 lead w/a 370-181 yd edge. The Vols have covered the L/4 vs SC. LW Tenn was off their loss to UGA and only led Mizou 28-24 3Q. The Vols scored the last 38 points and finished w/a ssn high 724 yds on a DEF that was allowing 303 ypg coming in. We won a 3★ on these pages and upgraded to a 4★ LPS going against SC in their 38-6 (+8) loss to FL. SC was outgained 515-237. They were missing RB MarShawn Lloyd (556, 5.6) and have a banged up secondary which now faces the SEC's leading WR, Jalin Hyatt (1116, 19.2, 15 td's). SC allowed 374 rush yds (6.9) vs FL and Tenn rushed for 264 LW and avg 196 (4.6) on the ssn. With the way Josh Heupel runs the score up (td w/:36 left LW) we don't mind laying a large number on the Vols who are 8-2 ATS and we've won our GOY twice going with Big Orange in 1984 & 1986!

LOUISVILLE by 4 over Nc State - The home team is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series. UL has won & cov'd 4 straight at home and this is their home finale. NCSt had won 17 straight home gms until LW's surprising 21-20 loss as an 18' HF. NCSt led 14-0 1Q and didn't relinquish the lead until BC scored the GW td with :14 left. UL lost both RB Evans and QB Cunningham in the 1H of UL's 31-16 (+7) loss at Clem. UL is 4-1 SU/ATS and +138 ypg at home with wins over Pitt & WF while NCSt is 1-2 SU/0-3 ATS and -83 ypg on the road. UL has the edge on offense, avg 421 ypg and NCSt only avg 350 ypg. Their results are nearly identical against 5 common foes, with both 1-4 ATS, NCSt is -75 ypg and -3 ppg while UL is -42 ypg and -3.4 ppg. We like the home team to win by under a td but will wait and see on Cunningham's availability.

WAKE FOREST by 6 over Syracuse - WF has won the L/2 mtgs but Cuse has covered 3 of the L/4. LY Cuse was +5' and led 14-3 2Q but WF won 40-37 in OT. After a 6-0 start, Cuse has now lost 4 straight including getting blown out 38-3 at home vs FSU and outgained 420-160. QB Shrader returned but only threw for 65 yds and RB Tucker had just 52 rush yds. WF started 6-1 but have lost 3 straight after LW's 36-34 (-4) home loss to NCar. Cuse's offense avg just 14 ppg and 221 ypg in their L/4 while their run D has wilted, allowing 233 ypg (4.6). WF doesn't have a stout run game to expose Cuse's weakness which is their run D. Both tms are going in the wrong direction and are desperate for a win so we expect a strong effort from both sides and with WF laying DD's we will side with the dog.

MICHIGAN ST by 16 over Indiana - Mich St has won 11 of 13 (9-4 ATS) in the series, incl a 20-15 (-4) win at IND LY, despite being outg'd 322-241. The Spartans (5-5 SU/ATS) are off a 27-21 (-9) home win over Rutgers & have now won 3 of their L/4 & need 1 more win to get to a bowl. Indiana has lost 7 straight (2-5 ATS) after a predictable 56-14 (+40) loss at Ohio St. Due to injuries & poor play, the Hoosiers have used 4 QBs in the last 3 gms & have been held to just 15 ppg & 246 ypg in those outings. Mich St is on a 3-1 ATS run & the Hoosiers have failed to cover in 3 straight, so we like the Spartans by over 2 tds in this one.

LIBERTY by 5 over Virginia Tech - Series is tied 1-1. In their last meeting in 2020 the Flamers won 38-35 as a 16' pt AD. While LU is 2-0 ATS in series this will be the first time they are the favorite. LW Liberty was in a huge flatspot off their first ever win over an SEC foe 21-19 over Arkansas & with hosting a P5 team here. They also had just lost their top RB Hunter (OFY). We won a Saturday Marquee going against the Flames LW as they were upset by UConn losing 36-33 as a 14 pt AF. LW VT lost their 7th straight SU (2-5 ATS). VT does have a rivalry game vs Virginia on deck. Liberty has the edges on both Off (#51-#116) & Def (#54-#71) but as you would expect VT has played a much tougher schedule (#74-#121). LU has opened as over a TD favorite & that may be enough to fire up a VT team to keep closer against a banged up Liberty.

CLEMSON by 17 over Miami, FI - Clemson has won the L/3 mtgs by 25, 35 & 58 (3-0 ATS). UM was on an 0-4 ATS run vs FBS foes until last week when the 'Canes beat GT 35-14 (+1) but it was only 14-7 mid Q and UM was +4 TO's and -10 yds. Clem is off a 31-16 (-7) win over L'ville. UM started true frosh Jacurri Brown LW and he did throw 3 td passes but he faces a much stiffer D in Clemson who allows 342 ypg and is holding foes 51 ypg below their avg. The 'Canes need a win to get bowl eligible while Clem has clinched the ACC Atlantic. Despite their struggles, UM is still +40 ypg and Clemson is only 3-9 as a double-digit fav since last year.

Ohio St by 34 over MARYLAND - Ohio St is 7-0 (5-2 ATS) in the series & has won 6 of those mtgs by 21 pts or more, incl a 66-17 (-21) beatdown in Cbus LY, in which they out'd MARY 598-335. The Buckeyes remained undefeated (10-0, 5-5 ATS) with an easy 56-14 (-40) home win over IND LW. After avg'g 365 tld yds on the prvs 3 wks (137 under ssn avg), the Ohio St Off exploded for 377 yds in just the 1H & scored tds on 4 of their 1st 6 poss. MD (6-4 SU) has lost 3 str & is on a 0-5 ATS run after their 30-0 (+10) loss at Penn St. The Terps were held to just 134 tld yds & are avg'g just 162 ypg the L2W. MD is just 1-10 ATS vs ranked B10 tms under Locksley & Ohio St wants to be hitting on all cylinders heading into their matchup against "That Team Up North," so we like the Buckeyes by nearly 5 tds in this one and we won our College GOY in '08 when OSU steamrolled NWestm 45-10 (-11).

MICHIGAN by 14 over Illinois - 1st mtg since '19. MICH has won 5 straight vs ILL, but the Illini have covered the L/2. ILL (7-3, 6-4 ATS) is off a 31-24 (6) home loss to PUR, in which they were out'd 379-303 & lost star RB Brown (1442 yds) in the 4Q (CS). The Illini now find themselves in a 4-way tie for 1st in the Big10W. MICH stayed undefeated (10-0, 5-4-1 ATS) with their 34-3 (+31) home win over NEB & have won 5 str by 21 pts or more. The Wolverine Def has held 9 of 10 opps under 300 tld yds TY, incl 6 str. The Illini are 5-2 ATS as an AD under Bielaema & MICH is 0-3-1 ATS as a DD HF TY, so we think the Illini Def (86 rush ypg) can keep the MICH rush attack somewhat in check & keep this one under the line, especially as MICH looks ahead to their showdown with Ohio St, which will likely determine a CFP playoff berth

PURDUE by 14 over Northwestern - NWest has won 6 of 8 over PUR, but the Boilers have won & covered in 2 of L/3, incl a 32-14 (-11) win over the Wildcats at Wrigley Field LY. PUR ended their 3 gm losing streak, with a 31-24 (+6) outright upset win at ILL LW. The Boilers (4-3 in Big10 play) now actually have a chance to play in the Big10W Title Gm if they win out & some other matchups go their way. NWest (1-9, 4-6 ATS) has lost 9 str, after their 31-3 (+18) loss at MIN. The Wildcats' Off has now been held to under 300 tld yds in 3 str. The home tm is just 1-8 ATS in the series & the Boilers are on a 1-3 ATS run, so we'll take the Wildcats with the pts in this one.

VIRGINIA by 6 over Coastal Carolina - First meeting. CC locked up a trip to the SBC title game with a 26-23 win vs SMiss despite not having QB McCall (foot inj) & the offense put up just 361 yds. UVA was crushed by Pitt 37-7 (-253 yds, QB Armstrong B2B pick-6's to open game). UVA has nothing to play for as they have had 3 wins while CC wants to keep winning & just cracked the top 25 again. CC does also have 24 sks TY and UVA has all'd 14 sks the L/3 gms. CC also has all'd just 76 rush ypg (2.5) the L/3 gms CC HC Chadwell is 9-2-1 ATS as an away dog, but without their star QB we see UVA being able to do enough to get the win as UVA has faced tougher competition as have the big schedule edge (#55 vs #117) here.

Georgia by 31 over KENTUCKY - UGA is 12-0 SU including 7 straight wins in Lexington. Last year we won our Oct Totals GOM on UGA/KY under 44'. UGA led 30-7 and KY added a td w/0:4 left for a backdoor cover. We won a 2★ on these pages and upgraded to a 3★ LPS with UGA beating Miss St 45-19 (-16'). The Dawgs have covered 4 of their L/5 and are allowing just 270 ypg. KY was upset at home by the same 24-21 (-17) by the same Vandy team UGA beat 55-0. QB Lewis threw for under 200 yards for the 3rd straight game and now they face a UGA D that held Tenn's vaunted offense to a ssn low 13 pts & 289 yds. Against 6 common foes, UGA is 6-0 SU/4-2 ATS, +27 ppg & +217 ypg while KY is 3-3 SU/ATS, -6 ppg & -22 ypg. HC Smart is now 19-8 as an AF, putting the Dawgs in the mix for our College GOY.

ARMY by 7 over Connecticut - Army is 2-1 SU & ATS vs UConn including a 52-21 win LY as a 32 pt HF. We won a Sat Marquee on UConn LW as they pulled the outright upset as a 13' pt HD over a ranked Liberty Still UConn blew a 21-10 2Q lead but then came from behind scoring a GW td w/5:43 left to win 36-33. With that win UConn became bowl eligible for the first time s/2015 & their fans rush the field. Army had their 2nd straight heart breaking loss LW as they lost 10-9 to Troy as a 9 pt AD. While Army can still get to 6 wins they can not make a bowl as they can only count 1 of their 2 wins over FCS foes toward bowl eligibility. Army's offense is not easy to prepare for & UConn will likely be a little hung over after their huge win but Army has opened as a DD fav & that may be too much as Army is just 1-5 ATS as a DD favorite.

EAST CAROLINA by 10 over Houston - HOU has won 3 in a row vs ECU, but failed to cover LY in a 31-24 (-13') home win. HOU (6-4, 3-7 ATS), has won 4 of 5 TY after they escaped with a 43-36 (-20) home win over Temple, in which they scored the winning TD with just 40 secs left, as QB Tune threw a 40 yd td pass for the win. Tune is avg 401 ypg over the L/3 & now has a 31-8 ratio on the yr. ECU (6-4, 7-3 ATS) is off a 27-25 (+5) loss at CIN, which ended the Pirates 3 gm win streak & any AAC Title Gm hopes. ECU out'd CIN 454-310, but all'd a kick return td & 2 td passes over 50 yds. HOU is 7-4 as an AD under Holgorsen, but the home tm is 4-2 ATS in the series. ECU is +7 in TO margin TY, while HOU is -6, so we'll side with the Pirates at home with this in mind.

Cincinnati by 14 over TEMPLE - Temple has covered 5 str in the series, until a 52-3 (+29.5) shellacking at CIN LY, in which they were out'd 542-234. The Owls (3-7, 7-3 ATS) have lost 5 of 6 AAC gms after their 43-36 (+20) loss at HOU. Temple scored with 1:22 left to take a 36-35 lead, but all'd a 40 yd td pass 42 secs later for the deciding margin. CIN is off a 27-25 (-5) home win over ECU, but are on an 0-6 ATS run. CIN was out'd 454-310, but scored on 3 plays over 50 yds, incl a 100 yd KOR & got a gm winning FG with 9:42 left 4Q. Temple is 5-0 ATS at home TY, while CIN is 0-5 ATS on the road, plus CIN has Tulane on deck with a potential AAC Title Gm trip on the line, so we like the Owls to keep this one a little closer than one might think.

APPALACHIAN ST by 13 over Old Dominion - App St is 2-0 SU/ATS all-time vs ODU, last met in 2016. App St is off a loss at Marshall while ODU was held to 227 yds & 3 pts in vs James Madison. App has a good rush offense and ODU's rush D allows 188 ypg vs SBC foes but just 3.7 ypc and ODU has a good pass rush (27 sks). ODU has faced the tougher schedule (#62 vs #114) and App St is just 1-3 ATS at home vs FBS foes TY. App St also tends to play to the level of their competition & ODU has just 2 losses by more than 2 td's. Our lean on ODU is just a slim one as they are just 1-6 ATS the L/7 gms & their top WR Jennings (959, 9 td) is banged up & missed LW. App St is also +93 ypg the L/4 gms while ODU is -132 ypg their L/4 gms, but vs common foes ODU is -126 ypg & App St is -18 ypg.

JAMES MADISON by 10 over Georgia St - Only the 2nd mtg. JMU got back in the win column LW with a 31-3 win at ODU (37-3, +265 yds) while GSt outgained ULM by 235 yds but ULM had a blk'd punt ret'd for a td as well as a pick-six to take the lead. GSt's strength on offense TY is their run gm (255, 4.7 L/4 gms) and while JMU is all'g just 79 ypg rush (2.5) they all'd 167 to Marshall & 244 to L'Ville. GSt did allow 450+ yds in 5 of their first 7 gms but the L/3 gms have all'd just 262 ypg but JMU's offense got back on track LW with 492 yds. Against 3 common foes JMU is +143 ypg while GSt is +12 ypg. JMU got back on track LW with a dominating win, while this gm should be closer than that, we'll lean with the Dukes here to win by DD's as they hold SBC foes to 326 ypg.

AUBURN by 10 over Wku - First meeting since '05 when Wku was still in the FCS. Wku did beat Ark 45-19 in '19 which resulted in the firing of Chad Morris. Aub has already made their coaching move and has played with better cohesion under Cadillac Williams. Aub can still make a bowl after beating A&M 13-10 (-1'). The Tigers controlled the clock, running 55-270 (4.9) but they've thrown for just 135 yds in the L/2. Wku has won their L/2 in blowout fashion, beating CLT by 52 & Rice by 35 but this is a huge step up in competition. The Toppers are +108 ypg but they've only faced our #126 sked while Aub has faced our #11 sked. This is Auburn's finale home game and Williams wants to send the Seniors out with a win.

NORTH CAROLINA by 21 over Georgia Tech - GT is 3-1 SU/ATS in this series and NC is out for revenge after losing 45-22 as 13' pt chalk in Atlanta LY. The Heels are now 9-1 and return home

after winning B2B on the road by just 5 total pts. LW NC was an AD and the Heels made a 33 yd fg w/2:12 left to win 36-34 and finished with +96 yd & +8 FD edges. GT is off a misleading final where they only trailed Miami 14-7 mid 4Q but lost 35-14. QB Maye's name is being brought up in Heisman talk thanks to his 31-3 ratio. GT has our #46 pass D (59%, 16-10) but Maye already shredded Pitt's #17 ranked pass D for 388. Against 5 common foes, GT is 3-2 SU/ATS, -3.8 ppg & -3 ypg while NC is 5-0 SU/3-2 ATS, +11.6 ppg & +65 ypg. NC's two most dominant wins this year were at home and they are on a 9-4 run as a HF vs FBS foes the L3Y.

TEXAS A&M by 35 over Massachusetts - First mtg. HC Fisher is 13-4 ATS vs non-conf foes and 7-2 as a favorite of 20+ vs non-conf. The Aggies have lost 6 straight games for the first time since 1972 and are not going to a bowl for the first time under Fischer. They were w/o their top passer, top rusher and #2 WR LW at Aub and lost 13-10, putting up just 215 yds. The Minutemen allowed a ssn low 275 yds and put up a ssn high 475 yds but somehow didn't pull the upset against Ark St, losing 35-33. If both teams play backups in a blowout the talent edge will be even wider for A&M who is loaded with 5★ recruits. We can't imagine putting a play on A&M who are just 2-7-1 ATS and even a lopsided win wouldn't really build any momentum.

LSU by 28 over Uab - LSU home finale. They last met in '13 when the Tigers were -34' and won 56-17. UAB did win here back in '00. UAB is off a misleading 41-21 (-6) win over NTx. UAB trailed 21-20 3Q and their final td came w/just :54 left. LSU clinched the SEC West LW, only beating Ark 13-10 (-3') but they were off their emotional win over Bama. The Tigers are 5-1 SU/ATS and +135 ypg at home while UAB is 0-4 SU/ATS on the road. UAB has a strong D but LSU has played a much tougher sked (#16 vs #99). The Blazers are 0-5 SU/ATS vs P5 foes and the avg loss is by 28 ppg, which coincidentally is where we put this line and the Tigers are only laying just over 2 td's.

Utah by 7 over RICE - UTSA has won L/6 mtgs and are 3-0 ATS vs the Owls, winning 45-0 LY w/a 403-102 yd edge. Rice still needs a win to get bowl elig for the first time under Bloomgren. The Owls lost 45-10 (+13') LW at WKU where they fell behind 21-0 2Q. The Owls benched TJ McMahon for Shawqui Itraish and both threw 2 int's. UTSA has won 7 straight including a 51-7 (-17) blowout of LA Tech LW. The Roadrunners have rushed for 214 (4.9) ypg in their L/4. A win here clinches a spot in the CUSA Title game for UTSA but Rice won't go down without a fight and did cover 4 straight as underdogs until LW's letdown. Rice is +78 ypg at home with wins over UAB and Louisiana so we think they stay within a td.

ARIZONA by 3 over Washington St - Following a 10 pt home win LW against ASU where they've moved their current P12 ATS run to 12-3-1, the Cougars head to the desert to take on a Wildcats squad that picked up a surprising 34-28 upset inside of the Rose Bowl against the Bruins with QB de Laura throwing for 315 yds and 3 tld TD's. WSU has won 4 of 5 (4-1 ATS) in this series including a 44-18 (-14) home victory LY where they finished with a 482-374 yd edge. The Wildcats have however covered 3 of their L/4 at home TY and have been a huge part to Northcoast's past history as far as Game of the Year's are concerned by delivering B2B 5★ Winners in each of our 1st 2 years of business ('82-'83). Do we feel nostalgic enough to go back to them this time around?

AIR FORCE by 27 over Colorado St - Since '17 AF has gone 3-1 SU/ATS against CSU. While CSU put up 468 yds vs SJSU 2 wks ago, their offense overall is avg'g just 288 ypg and the AF DEF is all'g just 263 ypg & holding foes to 90 ypg under their ssn avg. In the L/4 wks AF has all'd just 205 ypg & 9 ppg! AF's option is led by FB Roberts (1241, 5.3, 13 td) and CSU's run D has all'd a few big gms incl 209 to Boise & 252 to Utah St. CSU HC Norvell has seen this AF option but LY AF put up 476 rush (5.7) on his Nev team. AF is 5-2 ATS the L3Y as a DD HF and against common foes AF is +31 ypg and CSU is -110 ypg. With AF's strong DEF taking on a CSU offense getting held to 63 ypg under what foes allow (#116) we see the Falcons winning by nearly 4 td's. We used AF as a GOY winner back in 1997 against WY, and with a strong DEF we could go back to AF this ssn!

Oregon St by 8 over ARIZONA ST - The Beavers continued their dominance in Corvallis in a week ago against Cal with a 28 pt victory (21-10 FD & 362-156 yd edges). They now head into Tempe to take on an ASU squad that trailed 28-0 LW at HT in Pullman in the eventual 10 pt defeat. In their meeting a ssn ago, the Beavers (+3) picked up a 24-10 home upset against the Sun Devils with a 327-266 yd edge. While the away team in the series has gone just 3-9 SU (7-5 ATS), the Beavers are on a 10-3 ATS run overall dating back to the end of LY while ASU has failed to cover 3 of their L/4 in the desert.

San Jose St by 4 over UTAH ST - Since '12 SJSU is on a 0-6 SU/ATS slide against USU, but have only met 1 time since 2018. SJSU's DEF has all'd over 400 yds in B2B gms (all'd 258 ypg the F/8 gms) but have recorded 26 sks the L/5 gms & USU's OL has all'd 14 sks the L/3 gms and on offense they are avg'g 338 ypg in the L/4. USU does have the large ST edge (#37 vs #128) and the slight schedule edge (#100 vs #125), but against 3 common MW foes SJSU is +103 ypg/+21 ppg while USU is -61 ypg/-7 ppg. SJSU is also +10 in TO's TY and SJSU has just 5 total TO's this ssn as SJSU QB Cordeiro is an efficient player (2419, 60%, 14-3) & USU has all'd WY and Hawaii to gain over 500 yds in 2 of their L/3 gms. We see SJSU getting a close win here.

CALIFORNIA by 6 over Stanford - 125th edition of the "Big Game" with the Cardinal having a 65-48-11 lead that includes wins in 10 of the past 12 (8-4 ATS). Things didn't go right for Stanford LY on "The Farm" however as the Bears (-2) racked up 636 yds (most in series history) in the 41-11 victory (Cal largest MOV s/04). The Cardinal had no answer for the Utes LW in SLC as they had 29-9 FD and 514-177 yd deficits in a 35 pt defeat. The Bears also had their issues a week ago in Corvallis with OSU finishing with 21-10 and 362-156 yd edges in a 28 pt victory. While the away team is a perfect 6-0 ATS (5-1 SU) in this series, Stanford's consistent '22 struggles along with their 2-15 ATS run has us giving the Bears a small advantage.

WASHINGTON by 37 over Colorado - Following a rough road loss LW in LA where they were held to just 259 yds in a 55-17 defeat against the Trojans, the Buffs head North to take on a Huskies squad that got a 37-34 comeback win LW in Eugene with QB Penix throwing for 408 yds and 2 TD's. The past 2 meetings have taken place in Boulder with the Buffs surprisingly winning both as 14' and 6' pt dogs (20-17 win LY despite UW finishing w/a 426-183 yd edge, UW -4 TO's). While the Huskies have failed to cover 5 of 6 coming in, backing a Colorado team that's on a 4-13-1 ATS as an AD coming in could be risky.

Usc by 3 over UCLA - It's been quite a while since the battle for the Victory Bell has had this much meaning! The Bruins did however drop a surprising contest heading into this matchup LW at home against Arizona who scored 13 of the L/20 points in the 34-28 victory. The Trojans meanwhile have an extra day of rest heading into the Rose Bowl following a 38 pt Friday night win over Colorado where they finished with 27-14 FD and 531-259 yd edges. LY the Bruins (+3) won their 1st game at the Coliseum since '13 scoring the most points against USC in series history en route to a surprising 62-33 victory (609-484 yd edge). With USC now the favorite and UCLA off a surprising loss, this is a game we just want to watch and we will look at the total as we expect a shootout.

OREGON by 3 over Utah - Rematch of LY's P12 Title Game that saw the Utes (-2) pick up a 38-10 victory with 21-14 FD and 361-221 yard edges. Utah had no issue with LW's matchup against Stanford in SLC as RB Thomas rushed for 180 yds and 2 TD's in a 42-7 victory (-24) delivering a 2nd consecutive Early Bird Play of the Week Winner (free every Monday on our comp line!). The Ducks meanwhile saw their 23-game home winning streak snapped LW against the Huskies despite 32-23 FD and 592-522 yd edges. These two squads also met in LY's regular ssn with Utah picking up an easy 38-7 (-3) victory over the then #4 ranked Ducks (386-294 yd edge). While there's confidence on the side of the visitor in this one along with a 13-2 ATS mark as an AD, Oregon should have enough fire power to squeak out the outright win.

Over 40 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years including two this season! Here is This week's Underdog Play:

Iowa (+2') over MINNESOTA

Iowa over MINNESOTA - Iowa has won 7 str (5-1-1 ATS) vs the Gophers, incl a narrow 27-22 (-4') home win LY, despite being out'd 409-277. Iowa (6-4 SU/ATS) has won 3 in a row, off their 24-10 (+1) home win over WISC. The Hawkeyes were held to just 146 ttl yds, but forced 3 TOs, incl a 32 yd pick 6 that gave them a 14-3 lead in 2Q. The Iowa Def held WISC to just 51 rush yds (1.5 ypc) & are now all'g just 89 rush ypg TY. MIN is off a 31-3 (-17') home win over NWEST in which they rushed for 302 yds (5.2). RFR QB Kallikmanis got his 2nd career start & threw for just 64 yds. Iowa has covered 3 str at MIN & is on a 13 gm SU win streak in November, while MIN is on a 2-4 ATS run & has some questions at QB, so we like the Hawkeyes in an outright upset here.

Tcu by 1 over BAYLOR - BU is just 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS against TCU the L/7 mtgs, but BU is out for revenge after BU (-7) went to TCU LY and were upset by 3-5 TCU. TCU is off a big win at Texas while BU hosted KSt and were blown out 31-3 (-99 yds, -2 TO's). TCU QB Duggan is having a great ssn (2531, 66%, 25-2) but takes on the #31 pass D that has 12 int's this ssn incl 8 the L/3 gms. TCU's run offense avg's 220 (5.6) but BU's run D is allowing just 133 (3.8). On offense BU is led by their strong run gm (222, 4.8 L/4 gms) but TCU gives up just 135 rush ypg (3.8) incl holding Texas to 28 rush (1.3). We see BU performing better than LW as they are 9-3 ATS at home the L2Y, but we'll call for TCU to get the win as they keep finding ways to win every week & have a ton of confidence.

ARKANSAS by 3 over Ole Miss - Ole Miss is 3-1 SU but Ark is 8-1 ATS and the underdog is 10-1 ATS in this series. LY Ole Miss won a shootout 52-51 (+5') with Ark scoring on the final play but Pittman chose to go for 2. The Rebels led or were tied with Bama for the first 3Q and nearly handed Bama their 3rd loss of the ssn LW, only losing 34-28 (+11'). We won our Underdog POW with Ark LW despite the Hogs ply'g w/o QB Jefferson as they only lost 13-10 (+3') vs LSU. Ole Miss' bubble burst after LW's loss and against 4 common foes, Ark is +8 ppg while Ole Miss is -4 ppg. Ark has ply'd the tougher sked (#15 vs #63). We will ride the series trend and take the underdog Hogs to win by a fg. **South Alabama by 10 over SOUTHERN MISS** - These tms met in '20 & '21 as non-conf foes and SALa was 2-0 SU/ATS. SALa is off a 38-21 win vs TXSt while SMiss played Coastal w/o QB McCall and led 23-20 4Q but lost 26-23. The SMiss offense has struggled to move the ball this ssn, avg'g just 296 ypg vs SBC foes & they face a SALa DEF holding SBC foes to 83 ypg under their ssn avg. Overall in SBC play SALa is +124 ypg while SMiss is -69 ypg & against 4 common SBC foes SALa is +104 ypg while SMiss is -25 ypg. SALa's pass rush has 23 sks on the ssn & SMiss has all'd 13 sks the L/2 gms. SALa has covered their L/2 as an away fav & are 7-3 ATS overall on the season & we see them besting SMiss here by over a td as they need to keep pace w/ Troy in the SBC West race.

OKLAHOMA by 10 over Oklahoma St - 117th mtg of Bedlam! In the L/7 mtgs OU is 6-1 SU/ATS but OSU won outright LY, just their 3rd SU win vs OU s/03. The struggles continue for OU this ssn as they were upset at WVU last wk and need 1 win in their L/2 gms to get a bowl berth! OSU got a comeback 20-14 win LW vs Iowa St where inj'd QB Sanders came in off the bench & threw the go-ahead TD pass 4Q. Against common foes OU is -58 ypg but OSU is even worse at -116 ypg as they have been outgained in all but one B12 game TY & in their L/2 road gms are -7 TO's. OSU's rush D has all'd 206 ypg (5.3) the L/5 gms and OU's rush attack is avg'g 239 ypg (5.1) in the L/4 gms. We feel like OU will be able to move the ball on OSU and get the win as they are out for revenge & are at home.

Wisconsin by 20 over NEBRASKA - WISC has won 9 of 10 (7-3 ATS) vs NEB s/'11, incl 7 str. NEB, however, has covered 2 of the L/3, incl a 35-28 (+9.5) loss in Madison LY. The Huskers are off a 34-3 (+31) loss at Michigan that moved them to 3-7 SU/ATS & ended any bowl hopes. NEB has lost 4 str & is all'g 199 rush ypg in that span, while the Off is avg'g just 220 ypg the L/3 w/o starting QB Thompson. WISC moved to 5-5 SU/ATS after their 24-10 (-1') loss at Iowa LW, as they were held to just 51 rush yds & QB Mertz threw another pick 6. The home tm is 0-6 ATS in the series & Thompson is still a ? mark here for NEB (CS), which has us siding with WISC, who has delivered 3 5★ GOY winners since 2000! Could we ride with the Badgers again this year?

MISSOURI by 24 over New Mexico St - First mtg. The Tigers need to win out to get to a bowl and step one is beating a NMSU team that has won 3 straight. The Aggies do have blowout losses at Minn & Wisc but Eli Drinkwitz isn't the type to run the score up and their largest win this year is only 28 pts over LA Tech and they only beat Abil Christian by 17. MO kept up with Tenn for nearly 3Q, only trailing 28-24 but the Vols had no mercy in the 4Q and extended to a 66-24 final. NMSU was 0-2 ATS vs SEC foes LY (Bama & KY) in B2B wks but MO is just 1-4 ATS in non-conf home gms so we could see the dog staying within 4 td's.

TROY by 23 over Ulm - Troy won't be looking ULM TY as Troy was upset LY by them 29-16. ULM has won 2 gms in a row after their upset win at GST LW (-235 yds but had a pick-6 and blk'd punt re'd for a TD). Troy got past Army 10-9 LW with a go ahead TD pass mid 4Q (won top total 4★ on Under 47') and have now won 7 games in a row, but need to keep winning as they are tied with SALa for the SBC West lead & they own the tiebreaker. ULM's offense is avg'g 378 ypg the L/5 gms but face a Troy DEF holding SBC foes to 102 ypg under their avg. ULM QB Rogers is hitting 69% but Troy has all'd just 9 td passes all ssn & have 8 int's. Troy's offense puts up just 361 ypg vs SBC foes but ULM's DEF allows foes to gain 57 ypg above their avg (#120). We see Troy's DEF shutting ULM down and winning by over 3 td's at home.

BUFFALO by 6 over Akron - Home team is 9-2 SU & ATS in the series. Bulls have won 10 of L/13 SU including 4 straight SU & ATS outsourcing Akron by a combined 146-23 in those 4 gms. LW they only trailed EM 31-28 late 4Q & lost 34-28 by a 7 pt HD. LW Buffalo looked like 2 different teams. In the 1H they dominated CM leading 24-7 ay HT. They then forgot to come out in the 2H as they allowed a true frosh QB to put up 17 unanswered in the 3Q & lost 31-27 as a 2' pt AD. Bulls have the edge on both Off (#74-#106) & Def (#100-#123). The Bulls had won 5 straight SU & 6 straight ATS before their Bye but are 0-2 SU & ATS since. UB needs a win to become bowl eligible but have opened as over a 2 td favorite & that may be too much here. Akron has lost 9 straight games but they are 5-2 ATS their L/7 finishing with a yardage edge in 4 of those.

CHARLOTTE by 3 over Louisiana Tech - This is LT's first trip to CLT and their last as CUSA members with the 49ers moving to AAC. Neither tm is going bowling. This is Chris Reynolds last game at CLT and he faces a LT D that allows 471 ypg and 101 ypg more than their foes avg. The 49ers D has been equally dreadful, allowing 496 ypg and 104 ypg more than their foes avg. CLT did cover LW at Middle Tenn as 10' pt dogs, losing 24-14 and they did lead 14-7 at half and finished w/a 383-306 yd edge. LT is 0-6 SU/1-5 ATS and -138 ypg on the road after LW's 51-7 (+17) loss at UTSA. CLT is 0-5 SU/ATS and -145 ypg at home. Something has to give so we will take the veteran QB to win his final home game by a fg.

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 3 over Fau - MT dominated this series from '08-'16, winning 9 straight but they've split the L/4. FAU got a rare road win LW, blowing out FIU in the Shula Bowl 52-7. FAU scored pts on their first 4 drives and led 24-0 2Q. MT was w/o QB Cunningham but still beat CLT 24-

14 (-10'). Nicholas Vattiato had starting exp LY but only threw for 203 and 0 td's against the nation's worst pass D. The Owls still have a shot to make the CUSA Title game if they win out (need NT to lose). FAU is still just 3-12 SU on the road under Taggart while MT is 6-3 SU at home the L2Y and we like the Blue Raiders who need a win to get to a bowl.

UTEP by 17 over Fiu - The loser of this game won't be bowl eligible this year. UTEP is fresh off a bye after losing their last 2. FIU is off two straight blowouts by 38 at NTEXas and 45 LW in the Shula Bowl. FIU has road wins over CLT and NMSt but they are -157 ypg on the road while UTEP is +24 ypg at home. RB's Hankins and Awatt both have nearly 600 yds and should have success against an FIU D allowing 180 rush ypg (4.6) and last week they gave up 281 (4.7). The Miners do have home wins over Boise St and FAU so we will back the HF by over 2 td's.

TEXAS ST by 6 over Arkansas St - TXSt has covered 4 of the L/6 mtgs incl winning the L/2 mtgs both SU/ATS. Ark St got their 3rd win LW in a 2 pt win over UMass where they were outgained by 200 yds & out FD'd 25-11. TXSt has dropped their L/4 gms after their App St upset but 3 of those losses (Troy, SMiss, ULM) were by 6 pts or less. In the L/4 gms TXSt is -88 ypg but Ark St is -179 ypg in their L/4 & against common foes TXSt is -116 ypg but Ark St is -132 ypg. TXSt is dealing with a couple key losses on offense but we feel like they are the better tm here & will get the win as they are holding foes to 359 ypg their L/3 gms & Ark St hasn't topped 275 yds in 5 gms.

Marshall by 8 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - First mtg as FBS foes. MU is off a 28-21 win vs App while GS is off a loss to LA last Thur. GS avg's 334 pass ypg (#3 FBS) but MU comes in with the #6 pass D as they have all'd just 10 td passes all ssn & have 14 int's. Overall on DEF MU is all'g just 297 ypg vs SBC foes & in their L/4 gms are holding foes to 175 ypg under their avg! MU's offense is led by RB Laborn (1248, 5.0, 14 td) and GS has all'd 248 rush ypg (5.9) the L/5 gms. GS has also been outgained in 7 straight gms while MU has outgained all but 1 FBS foe. GS's OL had only all'd 5 sks all ssn but MU has 28 sks & GS isn't having success running the ball, avg'g just 97 ypg (3.2) the L/5 gms & MU's run D allows just 95 ypg (2.8) vs SBC tms. Against common foes MU is +83 ypg while GS is -40 ypg. We see MU's strong DEF limiting the GS pass attack & winning by over a TD.

Boise St by 10 over WYOMING - WY has 1 win over Boise but have covered 5 of the L/7 mtgs. A win by Boise puts them in the MW title game but a WY win would have them in position to go to the MW title gm. WY has won 4 straight gms but only by 9 ppg as they have been winning gms with DEF, holding their L/4 foes to 315 ypg & 15 ppg. WY also has 18 sks the L/4 gms. Boise also has a strong DEF, holding MW foes to 194 ypg & 12 ppg! They allow just 109 pass ypg (41%) in MW play and hold MW tms to just 85 rush ypg (2.5) & WY's offense is led by their rush attack that is avg'g 242 ypg (5.5) the L/4 gms. While we see Boise getting the win, we think WY will be able to keep this game close as WY is at home & typically have good crowds & are 5-2 ATS the L4Y as a HD.

Fresno St by 33 over NEVADA - Nev has covered 3 straight gms against Fresno, but this is a completely different Nev team. Fresno is peaking at the right time as they have won 5 straight & since coming back from inj QB Haener has thrown for 1,034 yds (80%, 10-2 ratio) in the L/3 gms. Fresno's DEF the L/4 gms is giving up just 336 ypg and Nev's offense struggles, putting up 275 ypg/15 ppg vs MW foes & their OL has all'd 16 sks the L/3 gms. Nev has covered just 1 of their L/7 gms and are -140 ypg/-19 ppg the L/4 gms. Against MW foes Fresno is +51 ypg/+12 ppg and Nev is -126 ypg/-18 ppg. After Boise put up 41 pts & 528 yds on Nev last week, we think Fresno & QB Haener can put up similar numbers & win big again a struggling Nev team that could be starting to look toward the future and playing younger players that the new coaching staff recruited.

Unlv by 7 over HAWAII - This is a battle of impressive ATS runs as UH is now 7-2 ATS in their L/9 gms, while UNLV is now 6-1 ATS in gms that QB Brumfield starts & finishes. UNLV is off their 5th straight loss after starting 4-1 TY, but fell by just 7 to Fresno while UH put up 538 yds & 34 pts but were -4 TO's against Utah St. Haw HC Chang has his team playing tough down the stretch and UH is just -47 ypg at home while UNLV is -100 ypg on the road. We will lean with the home dog here as UH is 5-1 ATS in MW gms this ssn & 4 of their 5 MW losses are by 7 pts or less.

TUESDAY NOVEMBER 22ND

OHIO by 10 over Bowling Green - Ohio is 5-1 SU & 4-2 ATS in series but BG pulled the 21-10 upset LY as a 6' pt HD. If BG upset Toledo or Ohio lost to Ball St LW then this game will be a big factor in deciding the MAC East race. If BG lost & Ohio won then Ohio will have the MAC Title game vs Toledo on deck. While BG has a slight edge on Def (#103-#108), Ohio has a huge edge on Off (#38-#128). While Ohio should take care of business here if they have the MAC Title game on deck they could rest some players and so our lean could drop some here.

MIAMI, OH by 3 over Ball St - Teams have played for the Red Bird Rivalry Trophy since 2017 with Miami going 4-1 SU & ATS including a 24-17 win last year as a 4 pt AD. While both teams are out of the MAC Title race, this will likely decide which of these teams become bowl eligible. Ball St actually has the edge on both Off (#113-#128) & Def (#80-#93). Still Miami is 16-2 SU their last 18 home games & the Home team is 5-2 SU & 4-3 ATS in the series.

4★ Las Vegas over DENVER - Following an unsuccessful trip to Nashville in their return from a bye where their offense once again saw their share of struggles (fewer than 17 pts for the 7th time in 9 gms!), the Broncos return to "Mile High" looking to stay ahead of the Raiders inside of the AFC West. The Raiders meanwhile blew yet another 4Q lead LW at home as the Colts (+4) finished with a 415-309 yd edge in a 25-20 victory. In their previous meeting back in Wk 4, the Raiders (-2) came away with a 32-23 home victory (25-12 FD & 385-299 yd edges). That victory by LV was their 5th straight in the series with DEN being outscored by 10 ppg in that span. In their midssn trip to MIN a year ago, the Cowboys (+2) got a GW 5-yd TD pass w/:51 left for the 20-16 victory (DAL QB Prescott out w/inj). While Prescott is expected to be under center this time around and DAL is 5-1 ATS as an AF, the Vikings have gone 17-6 ATS as a HD and should feel disrespected here getting points inside of their home venue.

2★ BUFFALO over Cleveland - After a rough trip to South Beach where the Dolphins finished with 29-20 FD and 491-297 yd edges in a 22 pt win, the Browns head back on the AFC East road to take on a Bills team that suffered a 33-30 OT loss LW at home against the Vikings (BUF 4 TO's!). The Browns and Bills last met back in '19 with CLE (-3) picking up a 19-16 victory (GW 7-yd TD pass w/1:44 left). With an angry BUF team going 10-5 ATS as a NDIV HF coming in and 6-2 ATS off a SU loss the past 2.5 yrs, it could be another long day for the visiting Browns in this one!

FORECAST: BUFFALO by 17

OTHER PLAYS

Tennessee at GREEN BAY - Thursday - Following a 7 pt victory LW in Nashville against the Broncos where we picked up a 3★ LP Winner on Under 39', the Titans head North to take on a Packers squad that ended a 5-game losing skid LW at home against the Cowboys with QB Rodgers throwing for 224 yds and 3 TD's. The Titans traveled to Lambeau just 2 years ago and had little success with the Packers (-3) picking up a 40-14 victory with 27-15 FD and 448-260 yd edges. Although GB is 13-6 ATS as home chalk, the Titans have gone 7-3 ATS as an AD while covering 7 straight overall coming in. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

BALTIMORE by 14 over Carolina - The schedule makers have been pretty generous for the Ravens as they return from their bye having played just 1 game since Oct 27th (23 days). While the Panthers also have some extra rest following a Thur night meeting against ATL where RB Foreman ran for 130 yds and a TD in a 25-15 win, they are riding just a 6-19 ATS run dating back to early LY. In their most recent matchup back in '18, the Panthers (+2) picked up a 36-21 home win finishing with a 386-325 yd edge. With CAR just 1-5 ATS as an AD coming in along with the Ravens sitting on a 3-game winning streak overall, we have no issue giving the home team a 2 TD edge.

Philadelphia by 7 over INDIANAPOLIS - The Eagles return to action on short rest following a MNF home meeting against the Commanders where they more than likely remained undefeated. They now take on a struggling Colts squad that suffered another loss LW in Las Vegas in the debut of interim HC Jeff Saturday (QB Ryan 21-28-222-1-0 in his return). The Eagles have squeezed out a trio of close victories in recent years against the Colts including a 20-16 (-7) home win in '18 (PHI 26-14 FD & 379-209 yd edges). With PHI pulling away late a few weeks back in HOU as a 2 TD favorite (29-17 win) and laying DD again as an AF in this one, we're cutting off our lean at a TD as the Colts have covered 5 of their L/7 when getting 10+ pts.

Washington by 6 over HOUSTON - This marks the 3rd consec matchup against the NFC for the Texans who dropped a 29-17 (+14) home meeting against the Eagles and a 24-16 (+4) road contest at the Giants where we picked up a 4★ Game of the Month Winner on NY! The Commanders meanwhile take to the road for the 3rd time in 4 weeks following a MNF trip to PHI. After losing their first 2 meetings to WAS back in '02 and '06, the Texans have now picked up 3 straight victories including a narrow 23-21 road win (-3) in '18. They have however failed to cover 10 of their L/12 against the NFC coming in which doesn't bode well against a WAS team that's 5-1 ATS as away chalk.

NEW ENGLAND by 1 over NY Jets - The Jets are on quite the run as they return from a bye having picked up wins in 5 of their L/6 overall including a shocking home upset of the Bills (+11) prior to their week off. That lone defeat did come against the Patriots at the end of October however who overcame a 387-288 yd disadvantage in the 22-17 victory (NYJ -2 TO's). The Patriots also earned a Wk 10 bye week while coming out victorious in 4 of their past 5 (26-3 win over IND back in Wk 9). While the Jets were 4-11 ATS as an AD the previous 2 ssns, they've actually won and covered each of their 3 contests in that role TY which should allow them to stay close (NE has a Thanksgiving trip to MIN on deck).

NY GIANTS by 7 over Detroit - The Giants returned from their bye a week ago picking up an 8 pt win at home against the Texans (4★ Game of the Month Winner on NY!) with RB Barkley having another big day (152 rush yds, 1 TD). The Lions meanwhile earned a comeback win (3 TD's in 4Q incl GW 1-yd TD run w/2:24 left for 1 pt vctory) LW in CHI. The Lions have knocked off the Giants in each of the past 2 matchups including a 31-26 home win (-6) in '19 with a GW 4-yd TD pass w/1:19 remaining. With DET having failed to cover 4 of their L/6 overall coming in and the Giants picking up covers in 5 of their past 6, we'll go ahead and give the home team a TD edge before both squads head into Thanksgiving action.

NEW ORLEANS by 5 over La Rams - This marks the 3rd HG in a 4-week span for the Saints who return to action following a 10 pt loss in PIT where they were held to just 10 FD's and 186 ttl yds. The Rams meanwhile dropped their 3rd consecutive contest since returning from their bye as the Cardinals led 17-3 at HT in the eventual 10 pt victory (QB

While the Saints are 3-7 ATS in NDIV HG's coming in, the Rams have gone just 2-8-1 ATS overall and appear to be the latest SB champ to miss out on the playoffs the following year.

ATLANTA by 1 over Chicago - The Falcons have fall on hard times as far as covering the spread is concerned, as after starting off the year with a 6-0 ATS run, they've gone 0-3-1 ATS since including a 10 pt loss last Thursday in Charlotte. The Bears meanwhile blew a 24-10 lead LW in the 4Q at home against the Lions despite another big day from QB Fields (314 ttl yds & 4 TD's). In their trip South to take on the Falcons in '20, the Bears (+3) overcame a 26-10 deficit in the 3Q with 3 unanswered TD's including the game-winner with 1:53 left. With the Falcons failing to cover 7 of their L/8 as home chalk coming in, we have no issue leaning with the visitor in this one as they continue to improve under 1st year HC Eberflus despite LW's blown victory.

Kansas City at LA CHARGERS - SNF - Key AFC West showdown that was flexed into SNF. The Chiefs had no issues knocking off the Jaguars LW in Arrowhead as QB Mahomes threw for 331 yds and 4 TD's. A banged-up Chargers squad meanwhile led 16-10 at HT (+7) before SF outscored them 12-0 in the 2H for an eventual 6 pt victory. In their 1st matchup back in Wk 2, the Chiefs (-4) overcame at 17-7 deficit in the 27-24 comeback victory (key 99 IR TD in 4Q, LAC 21-15 FD & 401-319 yd edges).
