KEY SELECTIONS

4★ KANSAS ST over Kansas - Sunflower showdown. KSt is on a 13-0 SU/10-3 ATS run against KU & have won the L/3 mtgs by 31 ppg. KSt is off a 48-31 win at WVU (+68 yds, FD's even, KSt had pick-6). KU was literally run all over by Texas as they all'd 427 rush yds (7.5i) in a 55-14 loss. KU did get QB Daniels back but the offense was held to 346 yds. While KSt has thrown the ball more lately (285 pass ypg, 67% L/4 gms) they still have a good run gm & KU is all'g 329 rush ypg (6.4) the L/4 gms & they also have the #101 pass D. KSt holds tms to 58 ypg under their avg & they have the #19 pass D (15 int's). Against B12 tms KSt is +50 ypg while KU is -87 ypg. KSt needs a win here to clinch a spot in the B12 title game & we see them taking down their rival by over 3 td's!

FORECAST: KANSAS ST by 25

3★ MARSHALL over Georgia St - With GSt blowing a 20-pt HT lead LW to JMU they are not bowl eligible TY while MU has won 4 of their L/5 gms SU/ATS after a 23-10 at GSthrm LW (+145 yds, +2 TO). GSt was up big LW at HT despite being just +41 yds (GSt ret'd 2 fumbles for TD's). MU's offense looked balanced LW as saw the return of RB Ali (1401, 5.6, 23 td in '21) and MU ran for 255 yds while QB Fancher threw for 274 & 2 td plus ran for a td. GSt was held to 257 yds LW and now face a MU DEF holding SBC foes to 106 ypg under their avg. GSt run for 228 ypg (4.7) but MU's run D allows just 91 ypg (3.0) and their pass D ranks #2 as they have all'd just 11 td's and have 15 int's! Against common foes MU is +117 ypg while GSt is -87 ypg & we'll back the much better DEF against a team with nothing left to play for this season.

FORECAST: MARSHALL by 15

3★ Lsu over TEXAS A&M - LSU is 9-2 SU/11-0 ATS in series. LSU has the SEC Title gm on deck but can't afford a loss for a potential playoff spot. LSU is only off UAB who they crushed 41-10 w/a 565-259 yd edge. LSU has one of the top true frosh in LB Harold Perkins who has 7.5 sks. A&M ended a 6 gm losing streak LW when they were -32' but only led 10-3 at half. They won 20-3 and were +236 yds but lost 4 fmbIs. They were w/o RB Achane and face an LSU D holding foes 95 ypg below their avg. The Tigers have also held their L/2 foes to their ssn low yds. LSU is on a 4-1 ATS run while A&M is 2-8-1 ATS TY. A&M has already started to see some of their younger players enter the Portal and Jimbo has to be looking forward to this season ending.

FORECAST: Lsu by 21

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ IOWA over Nebraska (Friday) - Iowa has won 7 str in vs NEB "The Heroes Game," but the Huskers have covered 3 of the L/4. The Hawkeyes won 28-21 (-1) in Lincoln LY to clinch their spot in the B10 Title Gm. Iowa is on a 4 gm SU/ATS win streak, after their 13-10 (+2') win at MINN LW & needs a win here to secure a return trip to Indy next week. The Hawkeyes have now won 14 str gms in Nov. Prior to all'g 312 rush yds to MIN, the Def had been dominant & are still all'g just 9 ppg & 265 ypg with 14 sks the L4W. NEB is off a 15-14 (+10') loss at WISC, which was their 4th loss in a row & the Huskers will miss a bowl for a 6th str yr. QB Thompson did return after missing the L/2 with inj & threw for just 106 yds & a 2-0 ratio. Neb allows 427 ypg and Iowa put up 393 & 376 yds when they ply'd the weaker D's of NW & Pur so we like the Hawkeyes to win by over 2 td's.

FORECAST: IOWA by 17

2★ PENN ST over Michigan St - Mich St has won & covered in 3 of the L/5 mtgs vs Penn St, incl a 30-27 (+4) upset win LY. The Spartans (5-6 SU/ATS) are off a 39-31 (-10) overtime loss to IND & need a win here to become bowl eligible. The Spartans Def is all'g 406 ypg in thr L/4 gms. PSU rolled to their 3rd str easy win, with a 55-10 (-19') win at RUT. The Nittany Lions have outscored their last 3 opps 130-24, while all'g just 166 ypg with 17 sks. Penn St is on a 5-0 ATS run & we'll side with the better Off, as the Nittany Lions have gained over 400 yds in 5 straight.

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 24TH

MISSISSIPPI by 9 over Mississippi St - The visitor is 7-0 ATS in the Egg Bowl and the last 5 mtgs have gone Under the Vegas Total despite offensive minded cch's Leach and Kiffin. LY MSU missed 2 fg's and were plagued w/dropped passes in 10 pt loss. The Bulldogs are only off an easy 56-7 (-38') win over FCS ETSU. The Rebels have lost 2 straight after falling 42-27 (-2) at Ark. They trailed 42-6 3Q and while they did put up a ssn high 703 yds, 410 came in the 2H. Miss St is allowing 184 rush ypg (4.8) vs SEC foes and now has to contend with the SEC's top RB duo in Judkins (1171, 5.7) and Evans (692, 6.1). Against 6 common foes Ole Miss is -4.3 ppg but +75 ypg while MSU is -0.3 ppg and -28 ypg. We think Ole Miss bounces back and gets a solid win to continue their Egg Bowl success.

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 25TH

NORTH CAROLINA by 4 over Nc State - NC has covered the L/4. LY the Heels led 30-21 w/2:12 left then NCST got a 64 yd td pass, recovered the onsides and went 54/3 for td and the 'Pack won 34-30 (-6'). NC is the king of close wins this year, pulling out 6 games by 7 points or less and it finally bit them back last week when they were upset by GTech 21-17 (-21)! Drake Maye threw for a ssn low 202 and Josh Downs dropped a crucial w/4:10 left. NCST was down to 3rd string QB Ben Finley LW and were missing 6 other starters in their 25-10 (+3) loss at L'ville. The Wolfpack still have a big edge on D here (#31 vs #126). NC has the ACC Title game on deck and if NCST is a little healthier, this gives us plenty of reason to think this game ends closer than expected.

TEXAS by 7 over Baylor - The home team has won & covered the L/3 mtgs. The 'Under' has also hit 9 straight times. Against B12 foes Tex is +66 ypg/+13 ppg and BU is +42 ypg/+1 ppg. Tex does run for 209 ypg (5.0) vs B12 foes incl rushing for 427 (7.5) LW at KU and BU's run D has allowed 172 (4.5) the L/4 gms. UT's run D has given up 123 (3.4) vs B12 foes but face a BU rush attack avg'g 212 (4.8) the L/4 gms. Tex QB Ewers has struggled with accuracy, hitting just 48% the L/4 gms and faces a BU pass D ranked #35 and they have 13 int's on the ssn. As a road dog in B12 play this ssn BU is 3-0 ATS with 3 outright upsets. While we don't see BU getting the outright upset, the spread is over a td & BU will keep it within the line.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Central Michigan - Winner will take home the Michigan MAC Trophy (between CM, EM, WM) as if CM is the current holder & if they win CM would retain as all 3 tms would be 1-1 this ssn. EM has a bowl game in their future, while CM will be home for the holidays. These rivals first met in 1902. Home team is 6-1 SU & 4-3 ATS. LY CM won 31-10 as a 8' pt HF with a 366-226 yd edge. LW EM showed the advantage of having an experienced backup QB as they lost their starter in the 1Q, while Kent St lost their's in 2Q. While KS's frosh QB struggled (6-12-150-1-0) in 2H with a 17-7 lead, QB Powell (30-39-315-3-0) led them to a comeback 31-24 win. EM has slight edges on both Off (#101-#103) & Def (#91-#94). EM is 36-11 as a dog since '16 so we have the Eagles winning by a fg.

Toledo by 9 over WESTERN MICHIGAN - While Toledo is 9-3 SU & 7-5 ATS in the series the Visitor is 1-5 SU & ATS. The Rockets have the MAC Championship on deck, but are off a heart-breaking loss to rival BG. With starting QB Finn out (check status), GT transfer QB Gleason, after trailing all game, led a 85 yd td drive to put them up 35-34 with :51 left but UT allowed a GW 42 yd td pass with :09 left. This is WM final game as they are 4-7 but are off a 12-10 win over rival CM on a snow covered field, kicking a GW 25 yd FG with 1:52 left. LY WM also faced a MAC Championship bound team (NIU), who's starting QB was banged up (DNP) and won 42-21 as a 3' pt AF. While UT may again sit QB Finn, they do not want to ride a 2 game losing streak into the MAC Championship game. UT has a huge edge on Off (#56-#125) and avg 35.1 ppg compared to WM avg just 18.9 ppg, so we look for the Rockets to get the win & cover here.

BOISE ST by 14 over Utah St - Boise has won & covered the L/5 mtgs, winning by an avg of 25 ppg. USU is off a 35-31 win vs SJSt (scored GW td w/ 2:49 left) that made them bowl eligible while Boise hung on to beat WY 20-17 & clinched a berth in the MW title gm. Boise is allowing just 210 ypg/13 ppg vs MW foes and holding them to 131 ypg under their avg! USU's offense is avg'g just 325 ypg the L/4 gms. As for USU's DEF they have allowed 205 rush ypg (4.8) the L/5 gms and Boise has ran for 212 ypg (5.0) the L/4 gms. Against 4 common MW foes Boise is +191 ypg while USU is -27 ypg. Boise is 5-1-1 ATS vs MW tms but with them locking up a spot in the MW title game they don't have much to play for here and USU has won 5 of their L/6 games and we see them keeping this game within the line as their L/3 losses were by 2 td's or less.

ARIZONA by 6 over Arizona St - Following a rough home outing against WSU where they trailed 31-6 entering the 4Q in the eventual 11 pt defeat (441-354 yd edge, -3 TO's), AZ welcomes a Sun Devils squad that suffered a 24 pt loss LW in Tempe against an OSU team that held ASU to just 7 pts, 13 FD's and 276 yds. AZ leads all-time series 49-45 but have dropped the past 5 (2-3 ATS) including LY where two 2H TO's saw a 14-9 HT deficit turn into a 38-15 defeat. While AZ has dropped 4 straight home finales coming in (2-2 ATS), this is clearly a different team in the 2nd yr of HC Fisch who knows how much a victory in the "Duel in the Desert" would mean for the program.

MISSOURI by 1 over Arkansas - MO had won 5 straight from '16-'20 in the Battle Line rivalry but Ark pulled away in the 2H last year for a 34-17 (-14') win. The Tigers only had NMST LW and won 45-14 (-29). Ark jumped to a 42-6 3Q lead over Ole Miss LW and while they did allow a ssn high 703 yds including 463 rush, most of it came in the 2H when they allowed 3 late td drives. Ark put up the most yds Ole Miss has allowed all ssn (503) with KJ Jefferson returning and Raheim 'Rocket' Sanders rushing for a career high 232. MO has a stout D, allowing 337 ypg and holding foes 67 ypg below their avg. Ark has a big edge on offense, putting up 102 ypg more than their foes allow and they've ply'd the tougher sked (#7 vs #48). We will go with the stronger D to win a close game at home.

COLORADO ST by 12 over New Mexico - CSU is 8-0 SU/7-1 ATS vs NMex since '12. CSU's offense failed to top 300 yds in their F/6 gms but in their L/4 gms they are avg'g 314 ypg. CSU's DEF has also shown improvement, all'g just 324 ypg the L/5 gms & NMex's offense has been awful TY as they have failed to top 300 yds in all but 1 gm vs FBS tms & avg just 217 ypg/11 ppg vs MW foes. Against 4 common MW foes CSU is -88 ypg/-14 ppg while NMex is even worse at -125 ypg/-20 ppg. Neither team can protect the QB well as CSU has all'd 55 sks and NMex has all'd 38! This has been a bad 1st year under new HC Norvell for CSU but they have the chance to end the ssn with a win over a bad NMex tm that is on a 0-6 ATS run & we see that happening.

Ucla by 7 over CALIFORNIA - Following a narrow home loss to rival USC a week ago where we picked up an easy 4★ LP Winner on Over 76.5 (93 tlt pts & 1162 tlt yds), UCLA (4-1 TO deficit vs USC) heads in to Berkeley having won 7 of the past 9 including a 42-14 (+6') win inside of the Rose Bowl LY where they scored 32 unanswered points after trailing 14-10 in the 2Q (UCLA 26-16 FD & 446-217 yd edges). The Bears return home after their 3rd "Big Game" win in 4 tries against Stanford where they overcame a 17-6 deficit in the 4Q with 3 TD's in the final frame (37-yd FR TD). Cal has gone 8-2 against the Bruins inside of Memorial Stadium while the HT in the series is 17-5 SU (15-6-1 ATS) overall. While backing the Bears for the outright win is out of the question, we'll happily take nearly DD's in this one as Cal is 9-4 ATS as a HD the L6Y.

FLORIDA ST by 5 over Florida - FSU looks like a legit top 10 team while coming off 4 straight blowout wins after beating Louisiana 49-17 (-24). FL was building momentum for next year until LW's 31-24 (-14) loss to Vandy where they had a 445-283 yd edge. FL's penalties allowed Vandy to extend two of their td drives after Gators stops, FL fumbled a punt into their own EZ and a FL int led to a 28/1 td drive. FSU won 5 straight mtgs from '13-'17 but Florida has won the L/3 including two against HC Norvell. Napier is 15-3-1 ATS as an underdog. FL probably won't catch all the bad breaks like last week so we like the Gators to stay within a touchdown.

FRESNO ST by 12 over Wyoming - Since 2012 Fresno is 5-1 SU/ATS vs WY. Fresno clinched a berth in the MW title gm LW with a 41-1 win at Nev while WY, who was up 10-6 HT despite being -145 yds, -8 FD's, had a chance to win vs Boise LW but a late end zone INT ruined their upset bid. WY's offense has leaned on the run game of late, as they are avg'g 279 rush ypg (6.9) the L/4 gms & their pass attack has put up just 100 ypg (44%) as starting QB Peasley has been banged up & missed LW (CS). Meanwhile QB Haener is avg'g 349 pass ypg (77%, 12-2) in the 4 gms since his return & Fresno is rolling, having won 6 straight (4-2 ATS) and WY does have the #81 pass D. While we see Fresno winning SU, WY is 6-2 ATS as a DD dog since '19 & Fresno has nothing to play for this week and could pull Haener & other starters to save them for the title gm.

CINCINNATI by 6 over Tulane - This matchup is for a trip to the AAC Title Gm. CIN has won 4 str in the series (3-1 ATS), but Tulane did cover LY in a 31-12 (+27.5) home loss. Tulane (9-2 SU/ATS) does have a couple extra days rest, after their 59-24 (-3.5) win over SMU last Thurs night. The Green Wave were actually out'd 470-451, but forced 5 TO's & outscored the Mustangs 49-14 through 3Q. CIN (9-2, 3-8 ATS) is off a 23-3 (-17) road win over Temple & are seeking their 4th con-sec trip to the AAC Title Gm. Tulane hasn't beaten a ranked team since 1984 (0-6!!). Cincy is used to playing in these big games so we lean with the Bearcats who have won 32 straight at home.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 26TH

OREGON ST by 1 over Oregon - The Civil War is the 5th longest rivalry (started in 1894) in college football history. After rebounding from the prior week's upset loss against the Huskies with a narrow 3 pt win over the Utes (QB Nix 287 pass yds & 1 TD on a bum ankle), the Ducks head into Corvallis looking for their 13th win in 15 tries (8-6 ATS run) against the Beavers in the battle for the Platypus Trophy. OSU comes in on quite the run following their 5th win in the L/6 contests (5-1 ATS) as they finished with 28-13 FD and 443-276 yd edges in the 31-7 victory. In LY's trip to Eugene, the Beavers outscored the Ducks 26-14 in the 2H but lost 38-29 as a 7 pt AD. With the HT going 6-1 SU (4-3 ATS) in recent contests and OSU winning 12 consecutive games SU and ATS inside of Reser Stadium coming in, the Beavers earn the mild upset in this one.

Purdue by 17 over INDIANA - These tms play for the "Old Oaken Bucket." PUR has won 3 of 4 in the series & has covered 5 in a row. The Boilers (7-4, 4-7 ATS) are off a 17-9 (-18') home win over NWEST & can clinch a spot in the Big10 Title Gm with a win here & an Iowa loss. PUR is now avg'g 66 yds more than their opps allow (#26), while all'g 11 yds less than their opps gain (#59). The Hoosiers (4-7 SU/ATS) have lost 7 of 8, but are off a 39-31 (10') OT win at Mich St, in which they were out'd 540-288 & trailed 24-7 at HT, but got 2 TDs over 75 yds in the 3Q to get back in the game. IND is avg'g 31 ypg less than their opps allow (#95) & is all'g 69 yds more than their opps gain (#124). IND is on a 1-3 ATS run, so we'll like PUR to cover their 6th str vs the Hoosiers.

Syracuse by 3 over BOSTON COLLEGE - Cuse has covered 8 of the L/12 mtgs and LY held the Eagles to 251 yds in a 21-6 (-6') win. The Orange started the season 6-0 but the schedule toughened and after 5 straight losses there are questions about Dino Babers job again. LW they led WF 21-10 2Q but the D wilted and Shrader threw a pick 6. Cuse did score the final 2 td's to lose 45-35 (+9'). BC never had a chance LW and lost 44-0 (-20') at ND. QB Moorhead was off B2B 300 yd passing performances but threw for just 117 and 3 int's. Cuse only allows 193 pass ypg vs ACC foes but they are missing their top CB. We can't back the Orange on a 5 game losing streak laying DD's on the road so we side with the underdog Eagles.

GEORGIA by 34 over Georgia Tech - The Bulldogs have had no mercy on GT during these recent down years, winning by 45, 45, 24 & 31 (4-0 ATS). UGA was held to a ssn low 16 pts and 363 yds by KY last week as we cashed our 4★ Top LP Totals play on the Under 48. GT was 3 td dogs LW and pulled the upset at NCar 21-17. GT does have losses by 31 to Clem & 42 to Ole Miss but those were under Collins and they haven't been blown out under Interim HC Key. This game is almost identical to last year's but the Dawgs could be playing walk-on's to finish and the home team is just 3-19-1 ATS. We've won our Totals GOY on UGA games twice recently, cashing on the 'Over' in this series in '19 and LY with the Under vs Mizuzzo! We could put this game in the mix again this year.

VIRGINIA TECH by 1 over Virginia - The Commonwealth Cup rivalry is being played under difficult circumstances following the death of 3 UVA players. The Cavaliers had their game cancelled last week so that they could memorialize their friends and teammates. VT pulled an inspiring upset over Liberty, winning 22-21 (+10). The Hokies ran for a ssn high 176 in the upset. With the recent tragedy within UVA's football program we don't feel comfortable putting a play on this game and will instead put this at the line.

Wake Forest by 2 over DUKE - WF has won the L/3 mtgs by 38, 12 & 52 but Duke did win 5 of 6 from '12-'17. The Deacons trailed Cuse 21-10 last week but scored the next 35 pts and led 45-21 (-9) before Cuse added 2 late td's & WF won by 10. QB Hartman was off B2B 3 int games and threw for 331 and 4 td's. Duke trailed Pitt 28-20 (+7) late 4Q and got a td on 4th & 18 after the Panthers had their punter drop a snap at the Pitt22. The blue Devils are +20 ypg in ACC play while WF is +9. Duke QB Riley Leonard has a 16-5 ratio and threw for 290 yds and 3 td's against a much better D in Pitt. The Blue Devils are 5-0 ATS at home this season while WF lost to L'ville and NCSt in their last 2 road trips but does have wins at FSU & Vandy so we like WF to win but Duke gets the cover.

Pittsburgh by 10 over MIAMI, FL - Pitt has lost the L/4 mtgs including LY when they were -9' but Tyler Van Dyke threw for 426 and the Panthers lost 38-34. There have been upsets in the L/8 mtgs. We were on the verge of winning a 4★ LPS on Pitt last week when they led 28-14 4Q but the Panthers allowed a 49 yd td pass, their punter dropped a snap at the Pitt22 then Duke scored on 4th & 18. True frosh QB JaCurri Brown had a rough start at Clem LW, throwing for just 53 yds (1 int) and the 'Canes only td came on a 10 yd drive after a Clem fumble. Things don't get any easier with Pitt's D who holds foes 76 ypg below their avg and allows just 314 ypg. Narduzzi is 13-3 as an AF and we will gladly take Pitt over a UM team who needs a win to reach a bowl but is on a 2-11 ATS run at home.

Army by 17 over MASSACHUSETTS - Army is 4-0 SU vs UMass but in FBS play are just 1-1 ATS as they were a 34- fav in both. LY Army as a 36 pt HF only led 19-17 early 4Q before scoring L/14 pts. UMass has covered 2 straight incl LW when they only lost 20-3 to Texas A&M as a 32' pt AF. They are 0-10 SU vs FBS foe losing by an avg 20 ppg but their last 4 have only lost by 12 ppg. Army has 4 straight covers but are just 4-2 SU & 3-3 ATS as a favorite this year. They have just 1 common foe in UConn. UMass lost 27-10 as a 15' pt AD. LW Army beat UConn 27-10 as a 10' pt HF but trailed 17-13 in 3Q before scoring the L/21 pts incl the front door cover 27 yd td drive with 4:23 left after an int. Army has the edges on Off (#100-#129) & Def (#72-#109) but Knights are a 20 pt AF & only have 2 wins by 20 pts TY so we will take an improving UMass & the pts here.

MARYLAND by 10 over Rutgers - MARY is 5-2 SU/ATS in the series, but Rutgers pulled the outright upset LTH here in '20, in a 27-24 (+6.5) win. The Knights (4-7, 6-5 ATS) have lost 4 str B10 gms after their 55-10 (+19) loss at Penn St, in which they were held to 167 tl yds & have been held to 180 yds or less in 3 of their L/4. After all'g 295 ypg in their first 8 gms, the Knights Def has all'd 441 ypg the L/3 gms. MARY (6-5, 5-6 ATS) has their own 3 gm losing streak, coming off their 43-30 (+27) loss to Ohio St. The Terps have been held under 200 tl yds the in 2 of their L/3, while all'g 226 rush ypg their L/4. MARY is on a 1-5 ATS run & the hm tm has failed to cover the L/3, plus RUT is 9-3 as an AD the L3Y. While we don't see another outright upset here, we do like the Knights with the pts.

CLEMSON by 20 over South Carolina - Clem has won 7 straight mtgs (5-2 ATS) including LY 30-0 w/a 364-206 yd edge. The home team is 0-4 ATS. Clem had a 447-98 yd edge LW vs Miami and won 40-10 (-19). QB Rattler had 8 td passes all ssn entering LW then torched Tenn's pass D for 438 yds and 6 td's, embarrassing the Vols (and wrecking our College GOY) in a 63-38 win as 22 pt dogs. The Tigers have a much tougher D and holds foes 75 ypg below their avg and allows just 214 pass ypg. SC's D is allowing 431 ypg on the road including 254 rush (5.2) and face Clem's Shipley (899, 5.8) and the Tigers have rushed for 210 (4.6) in their L/4. Clem does have the ACC Title game on deck but won't look ahead of their rival so we like Clem to win by nearly 3 td's.

Louisville by 4 over KENTUCKY - KY is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series and have dominated on the ground, rushing for 335 ypg in the L/5. The home team has lost 5 of the L/6 and is just 2-10-1 ATS in the Commonwealth Cup. UL is +66 ypg and have won 5 of their L/6 and their D is holding foes 68 ypg below their avg. KY is +14 ypg and their offense is being held 62 ypg below what their foes allow on avg. The 'Cats only lost 16-6 (+22) vs UGA LW. Will Lewis has been battling inj's thanks to the 41 sacks KY has allowed! UL is off a 25-10 win over NCSt while ply'g w/o Malik Cunningham. UL has 39 sacks this year led by Yarir Abdullah (8 sk) and their run D is much improved, allowing 139 ypg (3.8) while KY only avg 117 (3.3). We think the Cards get the win and will like them even more if Cunningham returns. Kentucky is 10-0-1 to the 'Under' this season so this game will absolutely be in the mix for our Totals GOY!

LIBERTY by 20 over New Mexico St - These 2 Independent foes will be CSUA foes next year. Three wks ago the Flames were 9-1, off their first ever win over an SEC foe & ranked the highest ever (#19). They have now dropped 2 straight SU both as a DD favorite incl a heart breaking loss as after trailing VT 17-7 they took a 22-17 lead into 4Q but lost 23-22. New Mexico St had a 3 gm winning streak come to an end LW as they were overpowered by SEC foe Missouri 45-14 just missing the cover as a 29 ppg. Liberty has the edges on both Off (#62-#128) & Def (#65-#118). They have opened as a 24 pt favorite but have just 1 win by over that this season (BYU) and while NMSt has lost 3 games by over 21 all 3 were vs Power 5 teams. While Liberty is clearly the better team, we think the Aggies will be able to keep it under 3 td's, so we will take the points here.

UCF by 24 over USF - UCF has won 5 in a row vs USF, but the Bulls have covered the L/2 mtgs, incl a 17-13 (+17) loss at UCF LY, in which they actually outg'd the Knights 312-285. It's been a ssn of turmoil for USF, as they have lost 2 QBs to inj & fired their coach a few wks ago. The Bulls (1-10 SU, 4-7 ATS) are off a 48-42 (+13) loss at Tulsa & have now lost 9 straight gms by an avg of 14 ppg & have yet to beat an FBS TY. UCF (8-3, 7-4 ATS) is off an unexpected 17-14 (-16) home loss to Navy, which cost the Knights a chance to host the AAC Title Gms & now needs a win here to secure their spot in that game. UCF is on an 5-2 ATS run & is 3-1 ATS on the road TY, while USF is 0-4 ATS at home, so we expect the Knights to take care of business with a title gm trip on the line.

East Carolina by 13 over TEMPLE - ECU has won 2 in a row vs Temple & has covered 3 str in the series, incl a 45-3 (-15) home win LY, in which they held the Owls to 168 tl yds. ECU got man-handled at home by HOU LW, in a 42-3 (-6) loss as they were outg'd 515-315, incl 435 yds thru the air. Temple moved to 3-8 (7-4 ATS) after their 23-3 (+17) home loss to CIN. The Owls have lost 5 of their L/6, but 3 of those losses have been by 11 pts or less & the Off is avg 452 ypg the L/3. The Pirates are on a 11-5 ATS run dating back to LY, but Temple has covered 4 of 5 TY & is 5-1 ATS at home TY, so we see this one right at the line.

BUFFALO by 7 over Kent St - HT has won & covered 4 straight & they have averaged a combined 79 ppg in those 4 gms with a series high 111 in 2020, if BG beat Ohio on Tues, then a UB win would send them to the MAC Championship game, if Ohio won then UB is only playing for bowl eligibility. Either way Kent St, who are locked into a losing season, look to play the role of spoiler here. LW UB's game vs Akron was postponed due to heavy snow closing roads between Buffalo & Akron. LW Kent St saw their bowl hopes dashed when QB Schlee (check status) was knocked out of the game in 2Q, as they led 17-7 at HT but true frosh QB Kargman struggled (7-19-91) & they lost to EM 31-24. The Bulls after LW's gm was cancelled still need a win to be bowl eligible here, so even if they can't win the MAC East, they will be focused here & they will get the win.

Appalachian St by 1 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - This rivalry dates back to their days as FCS foes, but as FBS foes App St is 4-3 SU vs GS & the Eagles have covered 4 straight incl 2 outright upsets in '18 and '19. App St became bowl eligible LW with a 27-14 win vs ODU (+104 yds) while GS lost their 3rd straight LW to Marshall (-145 yds, -2 TO's) and now need a win to become bowl eligible. GS's pass attack has "only" avg'd 258 ypg the L/4 gms (avg'd 358 ypg F/7 gms) but here face an App St pass D ranked #123. The big concern for GS is their DEF, esp their run D as they are all'g 235 ypg (5.6) vs SBC foes & App St runs for 189 ypg (4.9) incl topping 200 yds 3 times the L/5 gms. GS has been outgained by every SBC foe and against 5 common foes App is +7 ypg while GS is -74 ypg. We'll side with App to get the win, but this should be a close game.

JAMES MADISON by 10 over Coastal Carolina - While this is a battle for the SBC East Div title, CC has already locked up a spot in the title gm (JMU ineligible for title gm). CC had their gm at UVA canceled LW while JMU went down 34-14 at HT to GSt (JMU -41 yds, but 2 fumbles ret'd for TD's by GSt) but rallied to win the game 42-40 as JMU held GSt to 182 yds below their ssn avg. CC is w/o star QB McCall & 2 wks ago without him they put up just 361 yds in a close win vs SMiss & now face a DEF that holds SBC foes to 78 ypg under their avg and they allow just 75 rush ypg (2.4) against SBC foes. Against common SBC foes JMU is +103 ypg while CC is just +31 ypg but JMU is just +4 ppg while CC is +2 ppg. JMU wants bragging rights as being the true SBC East champ with a win here & we think they get it, but Coastal should be able to keep it within the line & Chadwell is 9-2-1 ATS as an AD.

Wku by 10 over FAU - WKU needs a win and a NTx loss to play in the CUSA Title gm while FAU needs a win to reach a bowl. The Toppers ran into a very motivated Auburn team LW and led 41-17 (+5) but the game was actually tied 17 all at half and WKU finished w/385-374 yd & 24-18 FD edges. FAU's road struggles continued LW when they were crushed 49-21 (+6) at Middle Tenn and they allowed 448 passing. Now they face QB Reed who has a 38-8 ratio and leads CUSA with 3,837 passing. FAU is 4-1 SU at home this year (+34 ypg) but against 6 common foes FAU is 4-2 SU/3-3 ATS, +6.6 ppg & -10 ypg while WKU is 5-1 SU/ATS, +25.6 ppg & +160 ypg. WKU has a solid edge in all 3 phases so we've got the 'Toppers winning by a td.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 21 over Old Dominion - Since joining the SBC in 2012 SALA will finish with a winning record for the 1st time. SALA has won 4 straight (3-1 ATS) and missed the cover by 0.5 pts LW when SMiss straight for a late FG down 10 pts before attempting an outside kick. ODU meanwhile has lost 5 straight (1-4 ATS). While ODU was down their top 2 pass catchers LW they had 308 pass yds but SALA has the #29 pass D (12 int's) and ODU (92 ypg, 3.5 ypc rush) likely won't be able to get much on the ground as SALA gives up just 87 rush ypg (3.0). Overall SALA holds tms to 71 ypg under their avg and SALA also has the ST edge (#24 vs #90). Against SBC tms SALA is +122 ypg while ODU is -90 ypg and we see the Jags closing out the reg ssn with their 10th win!

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 10 over Akron - Huskies are 11-5 all time vs Zips incl 6 straight wins (5-1 ATS). Last met in '19 when NIU won 49-0 win as a 22' pt HF. While Akron is again at the bottom of the MAC East for the 3rd time in 4 yrs as expected, LY's MAC Champion NIU did not expect to be at the bottom of the MAC West but losing QB Lombardi for all but 1 MAC gm (did not start) changed their trajectory. Against 4 common foes NIU is 1-3 SU & ATS with an avg 25-25 ppg with a 367-344 ypg edge while Akron is 0-4 SU & 2-2 ATS being outscored 36-23 ppg but with a 387-378 ypg edge. NIU has the edges on both Off (#82-#107) & Def (#111-#122). They should close the season with a win but Akron is on a 5-2 ATS run & could keep it close.

WISCONSIN by 6 over Minnesota - The "Battle for Paul Bunyan's Axe." MIN has covered 3 of 4 in the series, incl a 23-13 (+7) outright upset at home LY, in which they held the Badges to just 62 rush yds. MIN (7-4, 6-5 ATS) is off a 13-10 (-2) home loss to Iowa which ended any B10 Title Gm hopes. Starting QB Morgan (inj) has been in & out of the lineup the last few gms & the Gophers' pass attack has really struggled, avg'g just 110 pass ypg in their L/6 gms. The Def has kept them in gms by holding opps to 64 yds below their ssn avg (#27). WISC became bowl eligible for the 21st str ssn with a 15-14 (-10) win at NEB, in which they outg'd the Huskers 318-171 & have now held 3 str opps to under 200 yds. The home tm is just 1-6-1 in the series, but WISC has covered their L/2 at home TY by an avg of 9 pts, so we'll side with the Badgers in their final home game as they attempt to secure the permanent HC job for interim Leonhard.

OHIO ST by 6 over Michigan - 1st mtg of "The Game" in Columbus since 2018, as Mich DNP the Buckeyes in 2020 under the guise of the COVID pandemic. Ohio St had won 15 of 16 vs Mich prior to last yr's 42-27 (-7) road loss, as they were out rushed 297 (7.2 ypc) to 64 (2.1). Both tms enter undefeated & this one will determine a trip to the B10 Title Gm & likely the CFP. Mich has a slight edge on Def, all'g 108 yds less than opps avg (#4), while the Buckeyes are #18, all'g 76 yds less than opps avg. On Off, Ohio St is avg'g 148 yds more than opp avg (#2), while Mich is #14 with 91 yds above opps avg, as the Wolverines are only avg'g 209 pass ypg this ssn & RB Corum was banged up LW (check status). Ohio St has not lost a B10 gm since 2015 (29-0!), so while we expect the Buckeyes to win at home, the opening line is over a TD, which gives our lean to MICH.

Illinois by 11 over NORTHWESTERN - NWest has won 6 of L/7 for the "Land of Lincoln Trophy," but the ILL did win 47-14 (-6) LY as they outg'd the Wildcats 459-241. ILL is off a 19-17 (+17) loss at MICH & has lost 3 str TY after opening the ssn 7-1 & having B10 Title Gm aspirations. After avg'g 198 ypg rushing the 1st 8 gms, the Illini have been held to 134 ypg on the ground the L/3. In addition, the ILL Def has all'd 141 ypg rushing in the same 3 gm span, after all'g just 76 ypg the 1st 8. NWest is 1-10 (5-6 ATS) after their 17-9 (+18) loss at PUR & the Wildcats have not won a game on U.S. soil this yr, as their only win came way back in August over NEB in Dublin, Ireland. NWest is 5-2 ATS in the series & the home tm has won & covered 2 straight, so the Wildcats get the ATS nod in this one.

Utah by 38 over COLORADO - Following a 3 pt defeat in Eugene where QB Rising had a rough outing with 3 costly int's, the Utes head into Boulder to take on a Buffs squad that they've won the past 5 against by an avg of 21 ppg (28-13 win LY, 23-9 FD & 444-148 yd edges). The Buffs meanwhile return home following their 5th consecutive loss LW in Seattle as the Huskies had 29-10 FD and 575-202 yd edges in the 54-7 victory. While the Utes have struggled the past 2 years in the role as away chalk with just a 2-7 ATS mark, backing the Buffs is also a bit risky as well as they've covered just 2 of 11 matchups on the year.

NORTH TEXAS by 20 over Rice - A win here by North Texas puts them in the CUSA Title gm. Rice has lost 2 straight and still needs a win to reach a bowl for the first time under Bloomgren. The Mean Green are off a much needed bye and won the previous 2 games over WKU by 27 & FIU by 38 despite missing RB's Adeyi and Adaway. NT is on a 13-5 ATS run and are +115 ypg at home. The Mean Green have won 5 of the L/6 mtgs (4-2 ATS) including LY when they pulled it out 30-24 (+1) in OT. Rice was trounced 41-7 at home by UTSA. The Owls are 3-7 as an AD and their last 3 losses have been by 34, 35 & 33 while all 6 of NT's wins have come by 17 pts or more so we don't think NT has any trouble clearing the 14 pt line.



UNDERDOG PLAY OF THE WEEK

Over 40 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years including three this season after Iowa (+2) beat Minnesota 13-10. This play is now 9-3 on the season! Here is This week's Underdog Play:

Utep (+18) over UTSA

Utep (+) over UTSA - LY this was a rare home gm on national tv for UTEP and they were overwhelmed by UTSA in a 44-23 (+11) loss. The Roadrunners have the CUSA Title gm on deck. LY in the same situation they were -10 vs NTix and pulled many starters including QB Harris by the 2Q and lost 45-23. UTEP still needs a 6th win for a bowl after beating FIU 40-6 (-14) where they had a 525-71 yd edge despite missing QB Hardison (inj, CS)! If HC Traylor was willing to rest starters when the Roadrunners were undefeated and ranked LY, we figure there is no doubt he will do something similar here so we like the Miners to keep this very close. **FORECAST: UTSA by 6**

Byu by 5 over STANFORD - Third meeting. Stanford leads the series 2-0 (SU & ATS) with the last meeting in Provo back in '03 (Cardinal 22-27 all-time vs Ind tms). After a 26 pt win over FCS foe Dixie St a week ago at home (only led by 8 at HT, QB Hall 456 pass yds & 5 TD) to become bowl eligible on the year, the Cougars head to "The Farm" to take on a Cardinal team that dropped their 4th consecutive contest LW in Berkeley in the "Big Game" (400-393 yd edge, blew a 17-6 lead in 4Q!). Stanford has had some clear issues against the spread in recent contests with just a 2-16 mark. Despite that record, we expect them to stay within a TD here as the Cougars have had no success as away chalk with just a 5-10 ATS mark the L4Y.

UNLV by 21 over Nevada - Battle for the Fremont Cannon. UNLV is just the favorite in this series for the 2nd time since 2009. UNLV's bowl hopes were dashed LW when they were upset at Hawaii 31-25 & Nev's disaster ssn continued LW with a 41-14 loss vs Fresno & Nev is now on a 9 gm losing streak (1-8 ATS). Against common MW foes UNLV is -76 ypg, but 2 of those gms were w/o QB Brumfield, while Nev is -143 ypg. While this is the last gm for both tms, we have more confidence in UNLV to get the win as we cannot back Nev at all right now as they seemed to be focused on playing younger players for the future & a win for the Rebels would end this ssn on a high note for HC Arroyo's squad going into '23.

USC by 1 over Notre Dame - Following a 3 pt victory LW in the Rose Bowl against rival UCLA to clinch a spot in the P12 Title game (QB Williams 503 tll yds & 3 TD), the Trojans return home to take on non-confrival Notre Dame who collected a 44-0 victory over BC a week ago with 22-10 FD and 437-173 yd edges (5-1 TO edge). Prior to the Covid year of '20, this rivalry had taken place every year since 1946. In LY's South Bend meeting, the Irish (-7) led 24-3 heading into the 4Q of the eventual 31-16 win. While the HT in this series is on a 7-1 ATS run, the Trojans have gone 5-10 ATS as a HF the past 2 years. ND's Mayer is one of the top TE's in the country and USC allowed Utah's Kincaid to put up a school rec 16-232 and LW UCLA's TE Ezeike had 3 td's. With the Irish on an 8-1 ATS run away from home, we expect them to stay within the line in this one. The Trojans have gone 'Over' the Vegas Total in 5 straight and we did win a 4★ Totals play in LW's win over UCLA so could we go back to USC for our Totals GOY?

Washington by 5 over WASHINGTON ST - These in-state rivals have played for the Apple Cup each year since 1962. The Huskies picked up their 5th consecutive win a week ago in Seattle against the Buffs as they finished with 29-10 FD and 575-202 yd edges in the 47 pt victory. The Cougars meanwhile picked up a 3rd straight win LW in Tucson despite Arizona finishing with a 441-354 yd edge (WSU 4-1 TO edge). In their visit to UW a ssn ago, the Cougars (-1) broke a 7-gm losing skid against the Huskies (longest s/81) by scoring 20 pts on 4 UW TO's in a 40-13 victory (WSU 25-12 FD & 454-200 yd edges). With revenge on the mind of the Huskies this time around along with a 9-3 overall ATS run in the series, we expect the visitor to get the outright win for a 2nd consecutive ssn.

HOUSTON by 16 over Tulsa - HOU has won 3 str vs Tulsa (2-1 ATS), incl a 45-10 (-3.5) win at Tulsa LY, in which they outg'd the Hurricane 405-289. Tulsa enters this one at 4-7 (3-8 ATS) after a 48-42 (-13) home win over USF, in which they outg'd the Bulls 573-499 as they eclipsed 300 tll yds for the 1st time in 3 gms. The OL has been an issue during AAC play, as they've all'd 32 sks & are avg'g just 3.8 ypg vs AAC foes. HOU sits at 6-5 (4-7 ATS) off their dominant 42-3 (+6) win at ECU. QB Tune threw for 435 yds & 4 tds & has now thrown for 3459 yds (69%) with a 35-9 ratio TY. The home tm is just 1-9 ATS in the series, but Tulsa is on 0-6 ATS run & HOU wants to send their Sr class out in style in their last home game, so we like the Cougars in this situation.

SMU by 10 over Memphis - Memphis is 7-1 SU/ATS vs SMU since '14, but the Mustangs did win & cover the LTH in '20. SMU is off a disastrous 59-24 (+3) Thur Night loss at Tulane, in which they turned the ball over 5x as they fell behind 49-7 in the 3Q. The loss ended SMU's 3 gm SU & 4 gm ATS win streaks. Memphis (6-5, 4-6 ATS) became bowl eligible with a 59-0 win over FCS N Alabama & has now won 2 str after enduring a 4 gm losing streak prior. Despite the Tigers' dominance in the series, the home team has covered 3 of the L/4, so we'll side with Mustangs in their final HG.

TCU by 7 over Iowa St - TCU is just 2-4 SU/0-5-1 ATS against ISU s/16. The clock has not struck midnight yet for TCU as they were able to escape Waco LW with a 1-pt win on a FG to end the game & are the first B12 tm in the playoff era to start a ssn 11-0. ISU dropped their 6th B12 game by 7 pts or less LW with a 14-10 loss to Tex Tech (3★ LP Winner on Under 47!) despite being +176 yds, +1 TO as ISU missed 2 FG's and were SOD twice (164 yds on those 4 drives). Against B12 foes these tms put up similar numbers as TCU is +78 ypg while ISU is +64 ypg. TCU was held to 199 yds 2 wks ago at Texas & now face an ISU DEF that holds foes to 156 ypg under their avg (#1 FBS!). TCU has a spot in the B12 title gm locked up & we think they win outright here behind QB Duggan (2852, 26-3) but ISU is 3-1 ATS TY as an underdog and we think they can keep this game within the line. Also, Iowa St has now gone 'Under' the Vegas Total in 7 straight which puts them back on our radar for the Totals GOY!

Uab by 10 over LOUISIANA TECH - UAB has won 4 of the L/5 mtgs and LY they were off a shocking loss to Rice and won 52-38 (-13'). The Blazers needed a win to get bowl elig last week but most likely were more focused on this more winnable gm than LSU who they lost to 41-10 (outg'd 565-259). LT is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS at home with wins over UTEP & Middle Tenn while UAB is 0-5 SU/ATS on the road. The Bulldogs lost to CLT 26-21 LW, playing w/o QB Parker McNeil again and bkp Lyddy threw 2 int's. UAB is +139 ypg in CUSA play while LT is -86. We like the Blazers to get their 6th win but LT's home record combined with UAB's road record has us leaning with the dog.

Oklahoma by 7 over TEXAS TECH - OU has won 10 straight gms vs TT (7-3 ATS) incl winning & covering the L/3 gms. The 'Over' has also hit 11 straight gms with the L/5 mtgs avg'g 81 total points. Both tms reached 6 wins LW as OU beat rival OSU 28-13 but all 28 pts & 299 of their 434 total yds came in the 1Q. TT won 14-10 (3★ LP Winner on Under 47!) at ISU despite being -176 yds (ISU 2 missed FG's, SOD twice). OU's offense isn't the issue TY as they are avg'g 494 ypg in the 9 gms QB Gabriel starts & finishes, and OU's DEF has shown improvement & TT has all'd 7 of 8 B12 foes to gain 420+ yds. We see this being a high-scoring gm with OU coming out on top by a td.

OKLAHOMA ST by 10 over West Virginia - OSU has won & covered the L/7 mtgs vs WVU. OSU got behind 28-0 vs OU in the 1Q LW but held them scoreless the final 3Q's but still lost 28-13, but QB Sanders made his return as starter. WVU went with QB Greene as the starter & he threw for 204 & 3 td but also 2 int in a 48-31 loss. Both tms have been outgained in B12 play as WVU is -99 ypg while OSU is -92 ypg. OSU does avg 273 pass ypg vs B12 foes & Sanders threw for 381 LW and here they face the #121 pass D. WVU cannot make a bowl & this could be the final gm for HC Brown so OSU has more motivation in this game & we'll side with them by DD's.

SAN JOSE ST by 10 over Hawaii - SJSt has covered 4 of the L/5 mtgs vs UH. SJSt traded scores with USU last wk and gave up the GW TD with under 3 min left. UH got their 3rd win of the ssn LW, pulling the outright upset of UNLV 31-25 as QB Schager threw for 202 & 3 td's. While UH's DEF allows foes to gain 92 ypg above their avg (#129 FBS) SJSt's offense only avg's 321 ypg the L/4 gms & SJSt QB Cordeiro is facing his old tm here. SJSt already has reached 6 wins & while we see them getting the outright win, our lean is on Hawaii as they are on an 8-2 ATS run & are 6-1 ATS against MW foes incl 2 outright upsets.

Tennessee by 21 over VANDERBILT - Tenn has won the L/3 mtgs including the first under Heupel LY 45-21 (-31'). We have no explanation for how bad Tenn played LW in their 63-38 (-22) loss at SCar. The Vols allowed 606 yds and let QB Rattler throw for 6 td's despite coming in with only 10 td passes all ssn. Now the Vols have to regroup against a Vandy squad that has pulled B2B upsets as double-digit dogs, beating KY and FL. The 'Dores were outgained 445-283 LW in their 31-24 win over the Gators. Tenn will be without QB Hooker but bkp Joe Milton has starting experience and a huge arm. The Vols L/2 on the road have gone very poorly but will have a crowd edge here. Tenn still needs this for a NY6 Bowl and is 6-1 ATS off a SU loss so we have the Vols bouncing back again and winning by 3 td's.

ALABAMA by 17 over Auburn - Bama has won 10 of the L/14 in the Iron Bowl (8-6 ATS) and the home team has covered 9 of the L/10. The Tigers nearly pulled a huge upset LY as 20' pt dogs, leading 10-0 4Q but Bama won 24-22 in OT. Bama had an easy 34-0 win over Austin Peay LW and is back for their home finale. The Tide are 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS, +276 ypg at home. Auburn has won two straight under Interim HC Cadillac Williams and easily beat WKU 41-17 (-5') LW. The Tigers are 0-3 SU but 2-1 ATS on the road with losses to UGA, Ole Miss & Miss St. Aub has gotten back to running the ball, with Bigsby topping 100 in two straight. Aub needs a win to get bowl elig, and we think they put up enough of a fight to stay within 3 td's. Also five of the L/7 meetings have gone Under the Vegas Total and both teams have solid D's so this could be in the mix for GOY.

Troy by 20 over ARKANSAS ST - Troy is 2-5 SU vs Ark St since 2011 but have won & covered 2 of the L/3 mtgs. The home tm as also failed to cover the L/6 mtgs. Troy has won 8 straight gms (6-2 ATS) and need a win here to clinch a spot in the SBC title game. Ark St is just 3-8 TY and are just 1-6 SU against SBC foes. Ark St's offense has avg'd just 258 ypg/18 ppg and Troy's defense holds SBC foes to 274 ypg & 105 ypg under their avg. Against 5 common SBC foes Troy is +88 ypg while Ark St is -99 ypg. With Troy's DEF shutting teams down, Ark St will have a tough time scoring and Troy's offense will be able to move the ball on Ark St & get the win by nearly 3 TD's. We cashed our Oct Totals GOM on Troy vs TXSt Under so and we could look at the Trojans D to help us win our Totals GOY.

Southern Miss by 3 over ULM - SMiss got their 5th win a month ago & have been stuck on 5 wins ever since, as they have dropped 3 straight gms with their L/2 losses coming by 1 score to Coastal and SALA. ULM has avg'd just 314 ypg the L/4 gms but SMiss's DEF has all'd 433 ypg the L/4 gms. ULM however has a weak OL as they have all'd 31 sks incl 11 the L/3 gms & SMiss has a strong pass rush, with 35 sks (10.1%) on the ssn! ULM has found most of their success at home under HC Bowden as 7 of his 8 wins here are at home & is 6-3-1 ATS at home. However SMiss is 4-1 ATS on the road this season & we think SMiss has the overall talent edge and can get that elusive 6th win here and clinch a bowl berth.

Louisiana by 6 over TEXAS ST - LA owns the series vs TXSt as SBC foes, going 9-0 SU/8-1 ATS incl LY's 45-0 win (+205 yds, +2 TO's). LA needs a 6th win here to secure a bowl berth for a 5th straight ssn. Against common SBC foes LA is -8 ypg while TXSt is -60 ypg. LA does struggle on the road, as they are -65 ypg/11 ppg while TXSt at home this ssn but at home vs FBS foes TY TXSt is just +2 ypg. TXSt is also all'g just 342 ypg the L/4 gms while LA is avg'g just 32 ypg the L/4 gms and now are w/o QB Wooldrige for the ssn (inj). We see the Cajuns getting the win, but TXSt has 3 SBC losses by 7 or less and we see them hanging around.

Middle Tennessee by 24 over FIU - A few weeks ago FIU appeared to be on the improve after winning B2B gms over CLT & LT but have since been outscored 144-27 and outgained by 309 ypg in 3 blowout losses. MT is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series. The Blue Raiders continued their trend of winning or losing big LW in a 49-21 victory over FAU (-6). QB Cunningham ret'd from inj and threw for 448 & 5 td's. Every MT game has been decided by double-digits. This will be no different and given FIU's recent performances and against common foes, MT is +0.0 ppg/-8 ypg while FIU is -22.5 ppg/-188 ypg.

Air Force by 1 over SAN DIEGO ST - AF struggles against SDSt as they are on an 0-9 SU/2-7 ATS run vs the Aztecs. SDSt has won 5 of their L/6 gms and have covered 4 of their L/5 gms. This success is largely due to QB Jalen Mayden taking over, as he has thrown for 200+ yds in 5 of 6 starts. The SDSt DEF has also stepped up, all'g just 286 ypg/17 ppg the L/6 gms & in those 6 gms all'g just 60 rush ypg (2.7). They do face a strong AF option here led by FB Roberts (1425, 5.2, 14 td). They also face a strong AF DEF that is holding tms to 85 ypg under their avg & are all'g MW foes to gain just 274 ypg. The AF pass rush also has 14 sks the L/3 gms & SDSt's OL has given up 21 sks TY. The L/4 mtgs have been decided by 1 score & we see that happening again here.

4★ SEATTLE over Las Vegas - Following an OT win a week ago in DEN where we cashed a 4★ Newsletter Winner (WR Adams 141 rec yds & 2 TD's), the Raiders are back on the road for the 4th time in 5 weeks to take on a Seahawks squad that returns from their bye week (21-16 defeat in Germany against the Bucs in Wk 10). In their '18 meeting across the pond in London, the Seahawks (-3) finished with a 369-185 yd edge in their easy 27-3 victory. While the Raiders have covered 5 of their L/6 as a dog coming in, they've blown a handful of 2H leads throughout the ssn. With the Seahawks covering 4 of their past 5 at home and going 9-2 ATS against the AFC, we expect them to get the solid victory in this one. **FORECAST: SEATTLE by 12**

3★ Baltimore over JACKSONVILLE - The Ravens needed a strong 4Q against CAR in their return from bye as they scored 10 of their 13 pts in a 10 pt victory (BAL 19-13 FD & 308-205 yd edges). They now head South to take on a well-rested Jags team that returns from their own week off (8-3-1 ATS after a bye). In their most recent meeting back in '20, we easily cashed our 5★ NFL GOY on the Ravens (-13) who finished with 26-17 FD and 409-267 yd edges in the 40-14 win! While BAL has failed to cover 6 of their past 9 as away chalk coming in, the Jags are on a 4-14 ATS run overall and has 4 AG's in a 5-week span on deck. **FORECAST: Baltimore by 12**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ TENNESSEE over Cincinnati - Rematch of LY's AFC DIV Rnd that saw the Bengals (+4) go into Nashville and knock off the #1 seeded Titans, 19-16. That win by CIN was their 4th victory in 5 tries dating back to '11. The Titans continued to roll last Thur in Lambeau with their 7th SU win in 8 tries (8-0 ATS run) as they finished with a 408-271 yd edge in the 27-17 victory. The Bengals meanwhile returned from bye with a 7 pt victory in PIT where QB Burrow threw for 355 yds and 4 TD's. While CIN has covered 7 of their L/8 coming in and have gone 9-3-1 ATS away from home, the Titans are on too good of a roll at this point to go against, especially with a perfect 5-0 ATS run as a HD. **FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

Buffalo by 14 over DETROIT - Thursday - Well the Bills didn't have to go very far for their 2nd game in 4 days as they're back inside of Ford Field for the 2nd straight contest after their previous home matchup against the Browns was shifted to Motown due to heavy snow. In their meeting with CLE, the Bills jumped out to a 28-10 lead in the 4Q of an eventual 8 pt victory. The Lions meanwhile return home following a 2nd straight road upset (3rd consec win overall) LW at the Giants despite a 413-325 yd disadvantage (+3 TO's). The last 3 matchups have been close low-scoring affairs with the Bills winning by 1 ('18), 3 ('14) and 2 ('10). The Bills also had some solid success on Thanksgiving back in '19 with a 26-15 (+7) victory on the road against the Cowboys. With the Lions having less success in their traditional early holiday matchup (0-5 SU, 1-4 ATS), they may be in for a long day as BUF has gone 11-5 ATS in recent meetings with the NFC.

DALLAS by 13 over NY Giants - Thursday - Following a surprising 31-18 home loss against the Lions where a 3-0 TD deficit did them in, the Giants head to DAL on a short week looking to end a 3-game losing skid to the Cowboys. In their earlier Wk 3 meeting on MNF, DAL (+1) would finish with a 391-336 yd edge in the 23-16 victory. The Cowboys handed MIN just their 2nd loss of the ssn in blowout fashion as they finished with a 458-183 yd edge in a 40-3 victory. While the Giants have covered 5 of their past 7 meetings coming into this Thanksgiving matchup, they have failed to cover 5 of their L/7 NFC East contests. This doesn't bode well against a Cowboys squad that's 8-3 ATS as a HF and 8-1 ATS against their DIV.

New England at MINNESOTA - Thursday - After a home victory over the Jets where they got a GW 84-yd PR TD with :05 left (NE 13-6 FD & 297-103 yd edges), the Patriots head into MIN on Thanksgiving night to take on a Vikings squad that was embarrassed at home against the Cowboys (outgained 458-183 in 40-3 defeat). The Patriots have won 5 consecutive meetings with the Vikings (4-1 ATS, 16 pt avg MOV) including a 24-10 (-5) win where they had 27-16 FD and 471-278 yd edges. While they are also 7-3-1 ATS in recent AG's, this is the first of 3 road contests in a 4-week span. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Denver by 6 over CAROLINA - Rematch of SB 50, a matchup that saw the Broncos (+4) earn their 3rd Lombardi Trophy. Rough '22 campaigns continued for both squads a week ago as the Broncos dropped an OT matchup (3rd OT loss TY) to rival LV at home (LV 407-320 yd edge) and the Panthers fell by 10 in BAL with the Ravens finishing with a 308-205 yd edge (QB Mayfield 21-33-196 w/2 int's). DEN has clearly had some overall success in the all-time series history with CAR as well with 6 wins in 7 tries including a 32-27 win (+3) in Charlotte back in '20. While the Panthers are 7-2 ATS before a bye, we're backing the Broncos in this one as they've gone 8-4 ATS in NDIV AG's while also covering 6 of their past 8 against the NFC.

WASHINGTON by 6 over Atlanta - Following a 27-24 victory LW at home against the Bears where they connected on a GW 53-yd FG w/1:47 left, the Falcons head North to take on a WAS squad that picked up their 5th win in 6 tries LW in HOU finishing with 20-11 FD and 344-148 yd edges (3★ LP Winner on WAS). LY the Falcons saw their 6-game series winning streak snapped as WAS (-1) picked up a 34-30 road victory where they scored 2 TD's in the final 3:52 for the comeback win. While ATL is 10-4 ATS in away matchups overall, it's hard to go against a streaking Commanders squad at the moment, as they are on a 5-0-1 ATS run.

CLEVELAND by 3 over Tampa Bay - After an 8 pt loss against the Bills in Detroit (switched due to heavy snow) where they finished with 27-22 FD and 396-357 yd edges, the Browns return home with one more contest before the anticipated debut of Deshaun Watson under center. The Bucs meanwhile return to action well-rested following a bye week. Prior to their time off, the Bucs were able to string together a pair of victories including a 21-16 win over the Seahawks in Germany. After losing the first 5 matchups in this series between 1976-1995, the Bucs have now picked up victories in 4 of their past 5 meetings against the Browns including a 26-23 OT win back in '18. With cold temps potentially playing a role here for a warm-weathered visitor that's on just a 1-6-1 ATS run and have failed to cover 5 of their L/7 as a NDIV AF, we're giving the Browns a chance to grab the outright upset in this one as they've gone 8-3 ATS in recent battles against the NFC.

MIAMI by 8 over Houston - The Dolphins return to action following a nicely timed week off (4-1-1 ATS after a bye) and riding a 4-game winning streak. The Texans meanwhile have dropped 5 straight contests (12 pt avg defeat) since their bye week including a 23-10 home loss LW against the Commanders where they were held to just 11 FD's and 148 yds. In LY's meeting in South Beach, the Dolphins (-5) picked up a 17-9 victory (HOU leads all-time series 8-2!). While HOU is 3-8-1 ATS as a NDIV AD, we worry about MIA's focus here as they have failed to cover 5 of their past 7 and a trio of key road matchups on deck against the 49ers, Chargers and Bills!

NY JETS by 1 over Chicago - After a 3 pt loss in ATL where QB Fields was inj'd late in the 4Q, the Bears are back on the road for a 2nd straight week to take on a Jets squad that was held to just 6 FD's and 103 yds in a narrow 10-3 loss. The Bears have recorded 5 consecutive wins in this series (SU & ATS, 11 pt avg MOV) including a 24-10 win (-9) in '18 where they had 22-12 FD

and 395-207 yd edges. With CHI also going an outstanding 8-1-1 ATS against the AFC coming in and the Jets in a rare HF role (2-7 ATS as home chalk), we expect the Bears to stay within the line here if Fields is available (? as of presstime) as the Jets are just 3-7 ATS against the NFC.

La Chargers by 6 over ARIZONA - The Cardinals return home on short rest following a MNF trip to Mexico City to take on the 49ers where QB Kyler Murray missed his 2nd straight game with inj. The Chargers meanwhile saw the Chiefs get a GW 17-yd TD pass with :31 left for the 30-27 win. The Chargers have controlled this series in recent years with 4 wins in 5 tries including an easy 45-10 (-14) victory in '18 where they finished with 30-10 FD and 414-149 yd edges. While ARZ has gone 6-2-1 ATS before a bye and have covered 5 of their past 7 against the AFC, they have struggled inside of their home venue with just a 4-10 ATS mark. With the Chargers going 6-3-2 ATS against the NFC coming in, we'll give them an edge in this one.

KANSAS CITY by 17 over La Rams - Following a narrow 3 pt road win against the Chargers where TE Kelce had 115 rec yds and 3 TD's, the Chiefs return to Arrowhead to take on a struggling Rams team that dropped their 4th straight LW in the Superdome against the Saints with QB Stafford leaving with a 2nd concussion in as many weeks (bkp QB Perkins 5-10-64-0-0, 39 rush in relief). In their most recent meeting back in '18, the Rams (-3) ended a 6-game losing skid to the Chiefs in a 54-51 shootout victory that saw the teams combine for 1,000+ total yards. While KC has failed to cover 4 of their past 5 HG's, backing the Rams right now is risky as they're on just a 2-9-1 ATS run against the AFC while also failing to cover 10 of their 12 overall.

SAN FRANCISCO by 6 over New Orleans - After ending a 2-game losing skid LW in the Superdome against the Rams where QB Dalton was 21-25 for 260 yds and 3 TD's, the Saints match up against another NFC West squad in the 49ers who return home on short rest following a MNF meeting in Mexico City against the Cardinals. In their '20 matchup inside of the Superdome, the Saints (-10) took advantage of 4 SF TO's in a 27-13 victory. With the Saints going 18-7 ATS as an AD and SF struggling as home chalk with just a 5-12 ATS mark, we'll back the recent trends and call for the Saints to stay within a TD.

Green Bay at PHILADELPHIA - SNF - Following their 6th loss in 7 tries last Thur in Lambeau against the Titans where they had a 408-271 yd disadvantage, the Packers head East to take on an Eagles squad that overcame their first DD 4Q deficit since 2010 in a 17-16 victory over the Colts (GW 7-yd TD run w/1:20 left). In their most recent matchup back in '20, the Packers (-8) picked up a 30-16 home victory with a 437-278 yd edge. Something will have to give this time around however as GB is a solid 10-3 ATS as an AD while the Eagles have covered 8 of their past 9 as home chalk. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Pittsburgh at INDIANAPOLIS - MNF - After a 7 pt home defeat against rival CIN where they actually led by 3 at HT (CIN 408-351 yd edge), the Steelers head into Indy to take on a Colts squad that nearly pulled off a shocking upset as a TD HD against the Eagles (PHI GW TD w/1:20 left). Dating back to the 1985 ssn, the Steelers have absolutely dominated the series against the Colts with a 17-2 record that includes a 28-24 home win in '20 (IND led 24-7 in 3Q). While the Colts have covered 6 of their past 9 as a NDIV HF coming in, keep in mind that PIT has routinely done well as a dog with a 22-11-1 ATS mark.
