These 2 just met in '19's opener and Mack Brown's debut of his 2nd tenure when NC won 24-20 (+11). Brown is 15-9 in bowls while Shane Beamer is coaching his first bowl. NC has played in every version of this bowl (Continental Tire/Meineke Car Care/Belk) and they are 1-3 SU/ATS here. SCar ply'd here in '18 and lost 28-0 vs UVA. SC brought back 14 starters in HC Beamer's first season. QB

SC brought back 14 starters in HC Beamer's first season. QB Doty was inj'd in pressn so they were left with FCS transfers Zeb Noland (promoted from grad asst) and Jason Brown. They started 2-0 with Noland at QB when Doty ret'd from injury but had expected losses at UGA & vs KY. They lost Doty for the ssn in a 1 point win over Vandy. SC was 4-4 and coming off a 44-14 (+19') loss at A&M which gave us an easy OCt 5★ GOM winner. They switched to Brown to CR and upper Elevida as 20'; the providers At 5 Ethyr loss upset at QB and upset Florida as 20' pt home dogs. At 5-5 they also upset Auburn 21-17 (+7') to reach a bowl, finishing 6-6 after a blowout loss to Clemson. SC was -35 ypg on the season against our #39 sked. Their D was solid, holding foes 28 ypg below their avg but they only put up 322 ypg and avg 58 ypg less than their foes allowed.

NC had 18 starters back and were in the pressn top 10. QB Howell returned but they had to replace their top 2 RB's and WR's. They lost as road favorites at VTech and GTech but won their first 3 home games including by 20 over UVA. They fell behind FSU 35-17 4Q in their only home loss. They won their L/3 home games including over ACC Atlantic champ WF but finished 0-5 in road games, losing by 7 at Pitt, 10 at ND and blew a 9 pt lead late 4Q at NCSt. The Heels were +72 ypg despite their 6-6 record and their offense put up 72 ypg more than their foes all'd on avg. Their Oline was their biggest issue, allowing 45 sacks (12.5%) but SC's top pass rusher opted out. QB Howell had a disappointing 23-9 ratio but did top 100 rush on 5 occasions.

Our checklist favors SC but NC has big edges at the skill positions and they've got a huge coaching edge so we lean with the Heels.

FORECAST: NORTH CAROLINA RATING: 2★

First mtg. Tenn has won their last 4 bowls, all coming vs B10 foes. Heupel was 1-2 SU/ATS in bowls at UCF. Brohm is 3-1 SU/2-2 ATS in bowls. Tenn is 1-1 in the Music City Bowl, winning in '16 vs Neb while Pur was crushed 63-14 by Auburn in '18.

The Boilers ret'd 18 starters, but questions lingered over who would start at QB (Plummer or O'Connell). Plummer finished w/a 7/0 ratio but was pulled in the Illinois gm as Pur escaped at home 13-9 (-11) after the tm's 2-1 start (lost to ND). The Boilers lost at home to Minn in a rainstorm despite a 28-12 FD edge (+154 yds). Following a bye, the "Spoilermakers" were born, upsetting #2 Iowa on the road 24-7 w/WR Bell dominating (240, 21.8). Pur was rnk'd in the AP for the first time S/'07 but were dispatched by Wisc then pulled B2B upsets over Neb & #3 Mich St before being walloped at OSU 59-31. They finished w/B2B wins over NW and Indiana, hitting 8 wins in the reg-ssn for the 1st time in 15Y. HC Brohm made the right call as O'Connell finished 3178 (74%, 23/8).

Tenn was decimated by transfers (9 st'rs left) but HC Heupel added QB's Milton (Michigan) and Hooker (VTech). The Vols started 2-2 with losses to Pitt and at FL but Milton was inj'd and Hooker sparked the offense. They had B2B blowout wins over MO and SCar before a close loss to Ole Miss. At Barna they only trailed 31-24 4Q before giving up late td's in a 28 pt loss. The Vols won 3 of their L/4 to finish 7-5. Tenn avg'd 459 ypg and put up 106 ypg more than their foes all'd on avg (#6 in FBS). They all'd 405 ypg but their D performed better than the #'s indicate considering their offense finished dead last in the FBS in TOP. Tenn was among the nation's leaders with 94 tfl's. 4 of the Vols 5 losses were against tms that finished in the Cchs Top 12. Pur has had WR Bell (1286, 13.8) and DE Karlaftis (#6 tkl'r) both

opt out. Tenn has a HUGE ST's edge and crowd edge. Both teams run uptempo so there should be a lot of plays and lots of points.

RATING: 3★

FORECAST: OVER 63

HC Narduzzi was DC at MSU from '07'-'14. MSU is 6-0-1 all-time in this series but haven't met s/'07. Narduzzi is 1-3 SU/0-4 ATS in bowls while Mel Tucker is coaching his first bowl. Pitt is just 7-16 ATS in bowls since 1978 while MSU is on a 7-1 ATS Bowl run. Both teams are making their first trip here.

Pitt had 14 starters returning in 21 and was 2-0 after winning at Tenn but was upset at home by WMich 44-41 (-14'). The Panthers MICHIGAN STATE (10-2)

Lenn but was upset at nome by WMICH 44-41 (-14). The rarringers bounced back with 4 straight wins by double-digits including over Clemson. In a let down spot they were knocked off by Miami despite a +97 yd edge then rolled through ACC play with big wins over NCar & UVA to win the Coastal. In the ACC Title game Pitt intercepted Sam Hartman 4 times and won 45-21. Pitt finished +154 ypg and 45 ypg and 47 ypg more than their fores all their offense put up 503 ypg and 77 ypg more than their foes allowed on avg. QB Kenny Pickett re-wrote the school record books and finished 2nd in Heisman voting but he's opted out of this game along with Pitt's top CB Mathis (#7 tkl'r, 2 int).

Sparty was picked to finish last in the B10 East, w/ only Illinois

garnering less from the pressn. MSU ret'd 16 starters, but it was WF transfer RB Walker III who was the difference from the opening gm. Walker gashed NW for 264 (11.5) in an upset. Sparty began the yr 8-0 SU/7-1 ATS, defying every expectation as they skyrocketed to #3 in the polls. The highlight of this stretch was Walker's 5 TD performance against rival Mich at home in a huge comeback win. However, MSU was upended the very next wk on the road by the "Spoilermakers' They still controlled their own destiny in the East before losing at OSU (49-0 by HT). Sparty finished 10-2 w/a win over Penn St and Walker won the Doak Walker Award but has opted out of this game. MSU's

D has allowed 456 ypg and 56 ypg more than their foes avg (#112).

Both tms are missing their star player but Pitt bkp QB Patti still has the Biletnikoff winner to throw to and they've got the edge on D.

5th mtg, but first time in a bowl. Last mtg was in '13 when ASU won 32-30 at home. Wisc HC Chryst has taken his alma mater to a bowl all 7 ssn's here and is an impressive 5-1 SU/ATS while ASU is 0-2 SU/ATS in bowl games under HC Herm Edwards.

ASU got back 20 st'rs in '21. ASU opened the ssn 2-0 and then lost at BYU by 10 pts despite being +65 yds (-2TO's). ASU responded with at BYO by 10 pts despite being +65 yos (-210s). ASU responded with 3 straight wins incl a 42-23 upset win at UCLA. ASU then dropped 2 in a row by DD's incl a 34-21 loss at WSU (-4 TO's). ASU then picked up wins vs USC & at Wash, where they scored 21 straight pts in the 4Q to comeback & win. ASU fell at Oreg St by 14 then ended the ssn with a 23 pt win over rival Arizona. ASU avg'd 401 ypg for the ssn but over the L/4 gms avg'd just 346 ypg. The ASU rush attack avg'd 204 ypg (5.3) but RB's White & Trayanum will not play here & their starting RG is also out. ASU's D was strong (328 ypg all'd) and their rush D gave up 129 ypg (3.6). The ASU pass D is ranked #14 but will be without a starting CB and starting S. Despite 17 starters back, LB Chenal missed the first 2 gms w/

COVID, a fight between two RBs led to one's dismissal and the other in the portal, projected starter Berger was dismissed mid-ssn, another was OFY and starter Mellusi went down vs Rutgers. Left at RB was 17-yr-old and converted DB Allen, who ran for 100+ yds in 7 straight gms, all Badger wins, after the tm started 1-3. The defense was dominant wire-to-wire, holding tms to 240.8 ypg, statistically the only tm in the same hemisphere as Georgia. With the B10 West in their clutches, they dropped the Paul Bunyan Axe to Minnesota on the road in a 23-13 upse. Allen (1109, 7.1) does not turn 18 until after the ssn and could be a Heisman candidate in '22.

ASU is without their top 2 RB's & take on the #1 run D in the FBS Wisc also has the #7 ranked pass D. We agree with the checklist & see Wisc shutting down ASU and winning by double digits.

WF is 2-0 all-time vs Rutgers, winning back in '97 & '99. Rutgers is a late fill-in for Tx A&M and only have had a wk to prepare. WF won 3 straight bowls from '16-'18 but have lost their L/2. RU is ply'g their first bowl s/'14 and Schiano was 5-1 SU/ATS in bowls in his first tenure.

Rutgers had 21 starters back this year after going 3-6 in Schiano's first year of his 2nd tenure. They opened 3-0 vs a weak schedule, putting up just 195 yds vs Cuse but won by 10. They lost their F/4 in B10 play before winning at Illinois. RU lost 3 of their by blowouts against Wisc, Penn St & MD but did win at Indiana 38-3 and finished -7. The Scarlet Knights were -79 ypg and their offense only put up 14 ypg (held 77 ypg below opponents avg allowed). They haven't practiced in 3 weeks and only have a week to prepare. Rutgers was 0-6 SU/1-5 ATS vs bowl foes with the lone cover coming in September when they only lost to Big 10 Champ Michigan by a touchdown.

WF has 20 starters back and a gang of Super Seniors that made which has 20 starters back and a gaing of super seriors that made-his their deepest team ever. WF opened with 8 straight wins includ-ng 3 pt wins over L'ville & Cuse (OT) but their other 6 wins were by 25 ppg. They were up 18 over NCar in the 3Q but lost 58-55. They beat NCSt despite getting outgained by 76 yds and were no match for Clemson's D in a 21 pt loss but beat BC to win the Atlantic. QB Hartman had a meltdown in the ACC Title gm (4 int's) and WF lost 45-21, getting held to a ssn low 295 yds. WF is +45 ypg with their offense putting up 469 ypg and 105 ypg more than their foes allow on average (#7 in FBS)! Their D allows 424 ypg but did only give up 398 in their last 4.WF owns 5 wins over bowl eligible teams and ire 5-3 SU/4-4 ATS vs bowl foes.

It's really hard to gague how well Rutgers will play on short notice Some of their SR's may have signed agents and not be eligible.WF has a huge edge on offense but RU has the edge on D and ply'd a ougher sked. We would rather wait till gameday to make a play

WSU only played 4 gms in '20 and TY 18 st'rs ret'd and WSU started off 1-3 with losses to Utah St/Utah/USC but then won & covered their next 3 gms. HC Rolovich was dismissed but WSU still managed to win 3 of their L/4 Pac-12 gms incl wins at Ariz St & a 40-13 win at Wash. WSU's offense took off toward the end of the ssn (427 ypg/36 ppg) but will be w/o RB Borghi (880, 5.5, 12 td) as well as potentially 3 starting OL. WSU's defense held foes to 27 ypg under their ssn avg, but their run D was hot & cold (held 7 foes under 150 yds, gave up 210+ yds in 5 gms). WSU does have the #9 pass D as they picked off 14 passes but will be w/o CB Watson (12 sts) who opted out. WSU did end the the season on an 8-0-1 ATS run.

They got by App State then only trailed 24-17 but lost by 21 against a much better than expected Mich St team and QB King was OFY. The 'Canes lost B2B close games to UVA (missed 33 yd GW fg) and NCar (tipped pass int in RZ late 4Q). Frosh QB Van Dyke topped 300 in each of their L/6 with Miami winning 5 of them. Miami had 7 gms decided by 4 pts or less but did with their L/3 by 12.8 27 Van Dyke had 2.921 pags (629/ 25.6). They win their L/2 by 12 & 37. Van Dyke has 2,931 pass (62%, 25-6). They lost LY's #1 rusher, Cam Harris for the ssn and while RB Knighton has 561 but only 3.9 ypc. The 'Canes are +15 ypg against FBS foes but in the L/4 they were +127 ypg and they've got 4 wins over bowl foes.

The checklist can't pick a winner & neither can we as WSU is

dealing with opt outs while Miami may be dealing with covid issues.

The last time these 2 met was 1965. Mich is 2-0 all-time in the series. HC Smart is 3-2 SU/ATS and won UGA's only prior trip to the CFB Semi-Finals in '17. Mich is on an 0-4 SU/ATS run in bowls. UGA is 2-1 in the Orange Bowl but hasn't ply'd here s/1960 while Mich is 1-2 including a loss here in '16.

UGA was the SEC East fav this year what many felt was the best
D in the country. The Dawgs won their opener vs Clemson despite
not scoring an offensive td. JT Daniels started 3 of the F/4 at QB
but battled inj's so UGA turned to former w/o Stetson Bennett. The
Dawgs D didn't allow a 1st half td until the 7th game and Tenn was
the only team to top 13 pts in the reg ssn with just 17! The Dawgs
were 12-0, winning 11 straight gms by 24 pts or more but met their
match vs Bama who put up 41 points and 536 yds. UGA allowed
255 ypg and held foes 141 ypg below their avg. QB Bennett was
solid with 2325 (64%, 24-7) and the WR corps gets a boost with
George Pickens healthy after missing the first 10 games.

Mich ret'd 17 starters (10 on offense) but from a 1m that went just 2-4. Michigan responded by avg'g 350 rush ypg in non-conf (3 blowout wins). The Wolverines were tested by Rut at home and on the road in primetime vs Neb but did not play their first rnk'd foe until #8 Mich St. Michigan led 30-14 in the 2H but fell 37-33 despite a +157 yd edge. They won their next 4 SU/ATS, including a snowy "The Game", where Mich abused OSU on the ground and sacked then-Heisman favorite Stroud 4 times. Michigan features the top 2 sack leaders in the B10 in DE Hutchinson and LB Ojabo, the former now the single-ssn record holder for sacks by a Wolverine and B10 DPOY. Hutchinson was named B10 Title Gm MVP after Mich's 42-3 romp over lowa. Mich avg'd 224 rush ypg (10 sks all'd) and their OLine won the Joe Moore Award.

Mich passed 2 big tests, beating OSU and winning the B10 Title gm. Mich matches up well in the trenches so we see them keeping it close.

FORECAST: MICHIGAN (+)

RATING: 2★

Tms have met 5 times, but 1st time meeting in a bowl. CMich's last bowl win was in 2012 but since then have lost their L/5 bowl gms (1-4 ATS). This is the first bowl for Boise HC Andy Avalos & only Boise's 2nd bowl played gm since '17 (bowl gm in '18 cancelled).

Boise ret'd 17 str's, however they had a new HC in Avalos & his tenure began with a blown lead at UCF as Boise was up 24-14 HT but fell 36-31. After an easy win vs UTEP, Boise hosted Okla St & again blew a DD lead as they were up 20-7 in 1H but lost 21-20. After a win at USU Boise led Nev at HT 21-20 but fell 41-31. Boise upset BYU but then dropped their 3rd striaght home gm, losing to AF 24-17. After their bye Boise went on a 4 gm SU/ATS win streak (+147 ypg/+21 ppg) but then blew a 16-3 1H lead vs SDSt in the ssn finale & lost 27-16. For the ssn Bachmeier had his moments (3080, 65%, 20-7) but seemed to fall apart at times in the 2H. His favorite target was WR Shakir (1117, 14.5). Boise's success depends on their run gm as they avg'd 167 ypg (3.8) in wins & 54 ypg (1.8) in losses. Boise's D allowed 317 ypg the L/6 gms & their pass D ranked #40.

The Chips were just 1-11 in '18 but in '19 they hired Jim McElwain and he got them to 8-6 and a MAC West Title. They were 3-3 LY

The Chips were just 1-11 in '18 but in '19 they hired Jim McElwain and he got them to 8-6 and a MAC West Title. They were 3-3 LY and brought back 20 starters, also adding Washington transfer QB Jacob Sirmon. The Chips alternated losses with wins in their first 6 then beat Toledo by a fg. After losing on a late fg by 1 pt vs Northern Illinois the Chips rattled off 4 straight wins, all by 12 pts or more, to end the ssn and finished 8-4 and +60 ypg. RB Nichols led the MAC with 1,706 (5.5) including B2B 200 yard gms. CM avg 452 ypg and +34 ypg more than their foes allow. The Chips own 5 wins over bowl eliqible teams and ended the season on a 4 game ATS win streak.

FORECAST: CENTRAL MICHIGAN (+) RATING: 2*

Bama is 5-0 in this series but they haven't met s/1990. Cincy is in their first playoff game but did only lose to UGA 24-21 in LY's Peach Bowl. Bama has won 5 straight CFB Semi-Finals games (3-2 ATS) and they won the '15 Semi-Final over Mich St 38-0 in the Cotton Bowl.

The preseason fav to win the AAC, Cincy was hot off a perfect reg-ssn and AAC Title in '20. While the Bearcats were returning just 14 starters, they had 6 All-AAC performers back (4 1st-tm). Cincy's win over current-#5 Notre Dame in South Bend bolstered expectations. While not right away (won next 2 gms by a combined score of 108-24), they struggled to hang style pts every wk as pressure began to mount. Cincy lost 4 straight ATS while surviving scares at Navy and vs Tulsa but scorched a 2-loss SMU at home (led 48-0). They only led the AAC title gm at home vs Houston 14-13 at half but pulled away to win 35-20. CB Coby Bryant was named winner of the Jim Thorpe Award. Cincy was +124 ypg and their D allowed just 306 ypg (held foes 78 ypg below avg).

Bama had to replace a wealth of talent on offense with 4 1st round DC's gone at the skill positions. The Tide crushed Miami in the opener and was 5-0 after beating Ole Miss (led 35-0). They held a +143 yd edge over A&M but all'd the GW fg as time expired. They crushed Miss St in the 2H & won by 40, pulled away late vs Tenn to win by 28 then had close wins over Ark & Aub where they trailed 10-0 4Q & won in 4OT. In the SEC Title they let up UGA's vaunted D for 41 pts and 536 yds. Bryce Young threw for 4,315 (68%, 43-4) but has lost one of his top targets in WR Metchie (OFY). The Tide's D allows 304 ypg and holds foes 117 ypg below their avg and LB Will Anderson (15.5 sks) won the Nagurski and was SEC DEF POY.

Fickell doesn't want this to be a shootout and he's got the best CB duo in the country. Bama's D is by far the toughest test Ridder has faced so we see a lower scoring game with 2 great defenses.

KJ Jefferson has thrown for 2578 (67%, 21-3) and is also their #2 rusher (552, 4.5) but his top target, Treylon Burks (1123, 16.8) opted out, and no other Ark WR topped 300 yds. Penn St lost their first 5 gms LY before winning 4 in a row to end the ssn then with 16 starters back this ssn started on a 5 game win

the ssn then with 16 starters back this ssn started on a 5 game win streak. The Nittany Lions led at Iowa 17-3 before QB Clifford was knocked out of the gm and lowa stormed back for the 23-20 win. Following a bye, PSU rushed back Clifford and lost in 9OT at home to Illinois. They lost a third straight gm, a hard-fought battle at Ohio St, dropping from the rankings. The Nittany Lions did have Mich on the ropes at home but lost on a late TD. Penn St didn't beat a tm w/ a winning record after wk 3 and finished w/a losing conf record, hampered all yr long by their run gm (107, 3.1). The distraction of rumors Franklin was leaving for USC are over so PSU should be fully focused and WR Dotson (1171, 12.9) hasn't opted out yet.

HC Pittman's teams play best as big dogs but are only +1' and w/o their best playmaker, we see the better defense winning this game.

OSU lost at ISU but went on a tear in their next gms as they won by a comb'd score of 165-23 & were +313 ypg. OSU then came back from down 9 pts in the 4Q to beat rival OU but in the B12 title gm they were w/o RB Warren & they fell to Bay 21-16. OSU's offense was led by RB Warren (1134, 4.8) & they avg'd 465 ypg/40 ppg over their L/5 reg ssn gms (held to 333 yds/16 pts in B12 title gm). On D OSU all'd just 278 ypg/17 ppg & held foes to 146 ypg under their ssn avg (#3 FBS). The OSU D also has an FBS-best 53 sks incl 32 in their L/5 gms. OSU ended the ssn on a 9-1 ATS run. ND had only 9 starters back but added QB Coan from Wisc and were just in the CFB Semi Finals LY. They had closer than expected

The Irish ended the ssn on a 7-0 SU/ATS win streak and won us our 5 ★ GOV 28-3 over UVA and in their L/4 gms they were +35 ppg & +241 ypg. ND finished +77 ypg and their D held foes 67 ypg below their avg. They lost HC Kelly but replace him with DC Marcus Freeman who was loved by the players. ND has played in seven NY6/BCS bowl gms since 2000 & are are 0.7 SI/ATS & have been outscored 263-102. OSU comes in with

0-7 SU/ATS & have been outscored 263-102. OSU comes in with our #1 ranked D & ND is without their 1000-yd RB. OSU is currently the dog, but we agree with the checklist & think they win outright!

First mtg. KY has won their last 2 bowls in '18 & '19, but they haven't been fav'd in a bowl since '07. HC Ferentz is 9-8 in Bowls and they've won their L3. The Hawkeyes won their last trip here in '05 on a hail mary 56 yd td pass over LSU. KY won their only trip here in '19.

HC Stoops brought in LA Rams Asst Liam Coen as OC, Penn St

HC Stoops brought in LA Hams Asst Liam Oueri as Out, Ferm of transfer QB Will Levis and Neb transfer WR Wan'Dale Robinson to revitalize the offense. The plan worked early as KY started 6-0 including 4 SEC wins and averaged 409 ypg, 91 yds above '20's average. KY lost 3 straight including 2 games where they were held to 243 & 216 yds but also put up 612 in a 3 pt loss to Tenn (+151 yds). They were their L'2 games giving Stoops his 2nd 9 win regular season. won their L/3 games, giving Stoops his 2nd 9 win regular season. KY avg'd 430 ypg and was +92 ypg. RB Rodriguez is #2 in the SEC with 1,272 rush (6.2). QB Levis had a 9-3 ratio in the L/4 and even added a career high 113 rush in the finale at Lville. The 'Cats D holds foes 68 ypg below their avg but their pass D only comes in at #100 (220 ypg, 67%, 19-6). They are 5-3 SU/6-2 ATS vs bowl teams.

The Hawkeyes ret'd 14 starters but lowa made a statement early, w/a 34-6 route over then-#17 Indiana in the opener and a DD victory over then-#9 Iowa St the following wk. They trailed Colo St at home 14-7 but won the gm before completely embarrassing the Terps. Iowa beat #4 Penn St to reach 6-0 and #2 in the AP but were dominated by Purdue the next wk wQB Petras struggling (4 INTs). They gained just 156 total yds the next gm in a 20-pt loss to Wisky but took advantage of playing only one winning the in their final 4 gms (winning all of them) to finish the reg-ssn 10-2. For the 7th time this yr lowa was held under 280 yds of offense (only bowl tm to avg less than 300 ypg) in a 42-3 beatdown from Mich in the Big 10 Title gm. lowa is -29 ypg, their D holds foes 327 ypg and 76 ypg below their avg (#13 in FBS).

Tms only prior mtg was in 1986 in Columbus where OSU won 64-6. This is Utah's 1st trip to the Rose Bowl but HC Whittingham b4-6. This is obtains 1st the fit the hose bown but HC William and its 11-3 SU/9-5 ATS in bowls & is 4-1 ATS as a dog in bowls. OSU is playing in their 16th Rose Bowl (8-7 SU) but only their 4th trip since '97 & their last trip here was in '19 when they beat Wash 28-23.

Utah ret'd 19 st'rs in 2021, but they did lose their top QB & RB.

Utah opened with a win vs Weber St but then dropped B2B gms at BYU & SDSt. A switch was made to QB Rising & Utah won their next 3 gms incl a 42-26 upset at USC. Utah dropped their only Pac-12 gm at Oregon St 42-34. The Utes would go on to win their last 5 reg ssn gms (4 by DD's) incl a 38-7 blowout vs Oregon. The Utes would face the Ducks again in the Pac-12 title gm & again won 38-10. QB Rising led Utah st a 0.1 record cas started & he also not for 407 years. Rising led Utah at a 9-1 record as a starter & he also ran for 407 yds (6.5). In their L/6 gms Utah avg'd 262 rush ypg (5.9). On D the Utes held foes to 72 ypg under their ssn avg & all'd 122 rush ypg (3.6) while they also had the #24 pass D. Utah's D all'd just 232 ypg/13

ppg the L/5 gms and they collected 41 sks incl 19 the L/5 gms. OSU ret'd just 11 st'rs from a tm that played in the nat'l title LY while replacing a 1st Rd NFL QB. QB Stroud threw for the 2nd-most passing yds in a gm in school history, but Ohio St was upset 35-28 a home vs Oregon True Fr RB Henderson ran for 277 yds (3rd most in school history) the next wk vs Tulsa and the OSU offense quickly became the #1 unit in America, winning their next 4 gms by a comb'd 187 pts. OSU won B2B close gms vs Penn St and Nebraska, but rebounded w/ blowout wins over Purdue & Mich St by a comb'd 115-38. OSU's run D struggled vs Mich (297, 7.2) and OSU was handed their first-ever Big 10 loss under Day.

While OSU isn't playing for a nat'l title, a Rose Bowl berth still is a big deal. Utah won't go down without a fight but we feel like OSU's explosive offense will take over & propel them to a win.

Only the 2nd mtg (met in '75). Ole Miss plays in this bowl for the 10th time (6-3 SU) & their last trip was in '16 against Okla St (48-20 win). Baylor last played here just 2 yrs ago & lost to Georgia. Baylor HC Aranda cch's in his 1st bowl while Kiffin coaches his 5th bowl.

They only beat ULM by 13 but upset A&M 27-24 to get bowl elig. LSU is -50 ypg vs Power 5 foes. Their D allowed 372 ypg but LB Clark (#1 tkl'r in SEC) opted out. Their OL has struggled with inj's and all'd 38 sacks including 21 in their L/5 gms.

KSt ret'd 16 st'rs incl 10 on offense led by QB Thompson & RB Vaughn. KSt opened the ssn with a win vs Stanford then only beat FCS S.Illinois by 8 pts (QB Thompson inj'd) and despite bkp QB Howard starting KSt upset Nevada 38-17. KSt was down to a 3rd string QB vs OSU and lost 31-20. QB Thompson ret'd vs QU (320, 71%, 3-0) and KSt lost 37-31. KSt then lost to ISU at home. Down 24-10 to TT at HT KSt came back to win & that sparked a 4 gm SU/ATS win streak. KSt would drop the L/2 gms to finish 7-5 & Thompson missed the last gm due to inj but is on track to start here. In GB's Wk 11 trip to MIN back in November, the Vikings (+1) would pull off their 2nd straight upset of the Packers in exciting fashion with a GW 29-yd FG as time expired (QB's Rodgers and Cousins combined for 726 pass yds & 7 TD's). While the overall offensive output may be a little quieter this time around with potential wintry elements in Lambeau, we like the Packers (win here clinches #1 seed in NFC) to get some revenge this time around as they've gone 7-1 ATS in HG's along with an impressive 11-5 ATS in overall DIV matchups (MIN 1-5 ATS as a DIV ADI).

3★ TENNESSEE over Miami - The Dolphins are not only back on the road for a 2nd consecutive week, but they're also on short rest after taking on the Saints last Monday in the Superdome. The Titans on hand are in a perfect spot with extra rest after taking on the 49ers last Thur in Nashville. Despite trailing 10-0 at HT and finishing with 22-16 FD and 389-278 yd deficits, the Titans got a huge 2H from the returning AJ Brown (11 rec, 145 yds, TD) in the comeback win (GW 44-yd FG w/:04 left). The Dolphins have picked up wins in their past 2 meetings against the Titans including a 27-20 win in South Beach (*18). While MIA has won 6 straight (5-1 ATS) as of presstime, a win here by the Titans will clinch the top spot in the AFC South. FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 12 OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Detroit (+) over SEATTLE - After a 4 pt defeat LW in ATL where QB Tim Boyle (24-34-187-1-1) started for Jared Goff (Covid), the Lions head out West to take on a Seahawks squad that suffered a surprising upset in the snow against the Bears (CHI 26-18 FD edge, GW TD & 2 pt conv w/1:01 left. The Seahawks are on a 6-1 SU (4-3 ATS) run against the Lions including a 28-14 victory (+3) at Ford Field in '18 where they had a 413-331 yard edge. Despite that recent history, we expect the Lions to keep this matchup close as they are 9-4 ATS as a NDIV AD and have covered 6 of their L/7 overall coming in.

OTHER PLAYS

INDIANAPOLIS by 10 over Las Vegas - Following a solid home victory LW against the Broncos where we cashed our 5★ Game of the Year (LV 22-8 FD & 342-158 yd edges), the Raiders head to IND clinging to a remote chance of earning a WC berth in the AFC. The Colts meanwhile picked up a 22-16 win in the desert against the Cardinals with QB Carson Wentz throwing for 225 yds and 2 TD's. In their late season trip to "Sin City" a year ago, the Colts (+3) picked up their 6th win in 8 tries over the Raiders taking advantage of 3 LV TO's. With the Raiders failing to cover 6 of their past 8 matchups overall heading in and the Colts an outstanding 5-1 ATS as a NDIV HF, we expect the home team to grab a DD victory in this one.

CHICAGO by 3 over Ny Giants - The Giants are back on the road for a 2nd consecutive week following a trip to PHI that saw the Eagles finish with a 324-192 yd edge. The Bears meanwhile return from a long trip to the Pacific NW against the Seahawks where 3rd string QB Nick Foles led them to a shocking comeback victory (GW TD & 2 pt conv w/1:01 left). The Bears have won a pair of low-scoring affairs the past 2 years against the Giants including a 17-13 victory LY in Soldier Field (-5'). With minimal points likely in the forecast again this time around, we'll call for the road underdog Giants to stay within the line here as they've gone 19-9 ATS when getting points away from home.

Tampa Bay by 16 over NY JETS - The Bucs were able to bounce back from an ugly home loss to the Saints the previous weekend with a 26 pt victory LW in Charlotte where they finished with 21-16 FD and 391-273 yd edges (3★ LP Winner on Under 44'). The Jets also enter TW off a solid win LW at home against the Jags (2★ Newsletter Winner!). While the Jets own a 10-2 all-time series lead, the Bucs (+2') picked up a 15-10 victory in their most recent meeting in '17. With TB also going a solid 6-1-1 ATS vs AFC foes coming in and the Jets failing to cover 7 of their past 8 vs the NFC, we have no issue giving the visitor a substantial lean (Tom Brady 29-7 all-time vs NYJ). BUFFALO by 17 over Atlanta - After a big DIV win LW in Foxboro against the Patriots where QB Josh Allen had 378 ttl yds and 3 TD's, the Bills return home tied atop the AFC East with 2 games remaining. The Falcons meanwhile picked up their 1st home win of the year LW against the Lions despite 19-14 FD and 338-254 yd deficits. The Bills snapped a 4-game losing skid against the Falcons in their '17 trip to ATL as they took advantage of 3 Falcon TO's in the 23-17 win (ATL 25-15 FD & 391-281 yd edges). While the Falcons have gone an impressive 6-2 ATS in away contests along with covering 7 of their past 9 against the AFC, we expect the Bills (11-2 ATS vs NFC) to get the job done here as they've picked up ATS victories in 8 of their L/11 home games. DALLAS by 8 over Arizona - Huge matchup in the NFC between a pair of DIV leaders as the Cardinals head to DAL following yet another home loss LW against the Colts (3rd straight defeat, outscored by 10 ppg in that span). The Cowboys meanwhile had no issue disposing of WAS LW at home with 56 pts and 497 yds in a 42 pt victory. In the Cardinals' MNF trip to DAL a season ago, ARZ finished with a 438-344 yard edge in an easy 38-10 victory. With QB Dak Prescott expected to play this time around for the Cowboys along with an impressive 16-4 overall ATS run by his squad coming in, we have no issue giving DAL the TD edge h

NEW ORLEANS by 10 over Carolina - While the Saints are back inside of the Superdome for a 2nd consecutive week, they do head into action on short rest after taking on the Dolphins on MNF. The Panthers on the other hand have suffered 5 straight defeats coming in after a 26 pt home loss to the Bucs where they were held to just 16 FD's and 273 yds (3★ LP Winner on Under 44'). In their 1st matchup in Charlotte way back in Wk 2, the Panthers (+3) picked up a surprising 26-7 upset victory (28-6 FD & 383-128 yd edges) ending a 4-game series losing streak. With revenge on the mind of the Saints this time around along with a potential chance to remain alive for one of the final WC spots in the NFC, we're backing the home team in this one as NO is 11-5 ATS in recent NFC South contests.

Philadelphia by 7 over WASHINGTON - This marks the 2nd matchup between PHI and WAS in just 12 days as their last meeting was moved back to 12/21 (Tuesday) due to Covid. In that contest, the Eagles overcame a shaky start to pick up a 27-17 victory (23-14 FD & 519-237 yd edges). LW the Eagles picked up a dominant 24 pt victory over the Giants allowing just 192 ttl yds. WAS meanwhile was blown out 56-14 LW in DAL. Both squads have struggled in this situation as of late with PHI failing to cover 7 of their L/10 inside of the NFC East while WAS is just 5-12 ATS in DIV HG's. With WAS looking lost against the Cowboys on the defensive side of the ball and PHI starting to show more production on offense, we'll go ahead and give the visitor a TD edge in this one. Kansas City by 2 over CINCINNATI - Following a 26 pt victory over the Steelers LW in Arrowhead where Patrick Mahomes threw for 258 yds and 3 TD's, the Chiefs (#1 seed in the AFC) head on the road to take on a Bengals squad that demolished a wounded Ravens squad with Joe Burrow

up an easy 45-10 victory ending a 4-game losing skid. While KC has picked up covers in 4 of their L/5 road contests coming in while covering their past 6 overall, we're expecting the Bengals to keep this one within a FG as they're a solid 8-4-1 ATS when listed as a HD.

NEW ENGLAND by 21 over Jacksonville - The Patriots are back in Foxboro for a 2nd consecutive week following a 12 pt home loss to the Bills to move them back into a tie atop the AFC East (QB Jones 14-32-145-0-2). The Jags meanwhile moved 1 game closer to getting the 1st overall pick in the 2022 Draft after a 5 pt road loss to the Jets. In their most recent matchup back in '18, the Jaguars (+1') snapped an 8-game losing skid against NE with a 31-20 victory (JAX 27-18 FD & 481-302 yd edges). With NE covering 7 of their past 9 overall coming in along with JAX failing to cover 7 of their past 9 away contests, we have no issue giving the hometown Patriots a 3 TD lean in this one. LA CHARGERS by 1 over Denver - The Broncos are back on the road for a 2nd straight week after seeing their slim playoff hopes dashed LW against the Raiders who held them to just 8 FD's and 158 yds (5★ GOY Winner on LV!). The Chargers on the other hand suffered a shocking road loss to the Texans to potentially damage some AFC Wild Card aspirations. In LA's late November trip to "Mille High" as a 2'pt favorite, the Broncos would pick up their 4th upset in 5 tries over the Chargers in a 28-13 victory. With DEN clearly having the Chargers' number in recent matchups and LA's porous 8-20-2 ATS mark as an overall favorite, we'll go ahead and call for the Broncos to keep this meeting extremely tight no matter who lines up at QB for DEN.

SAN FRANCISCO by 17 over Houston - The 49ers return home with extra rest following a Thur night trip to Nashville where they blew a 10-0 lead in an eventual 20-17 loss (SF 22-16 FD & 389-278 yd edges, -2 TO's). The Texans meanwhile picked up a surprising 41-29 win LW at home against the Chargers with rookie QB Davis Mills throwing for 254 yds and 2 TD's. The 49ers own a 3-1 SU (3-0-1 ATS) edge in all-time matchups with the Texans including a 26-16 victory in HOU ('17) where they had a 416-311 yard edge. While the 49ers had failed to cash 11 straight as a HF, they have actually covered the L/2 including an 18 pt win over ATL (-9') a few weeks back. With the Texans having gone just 1-6-1 ATS in recent matchups against the NFC, they might be in for

BALTIMORE by 3 over La Rams - Following a rough road trip to Cincy LW (20 pt loss) where 3rd string QB Josh Johnson threw for 304 yds (2-1 ratio) with Lamar Jackson (ankle) and Tyler Huntley (Covid) out, the Ravens are back at home to take on a Rams squad that moved into 1st place in the NFC West with a 7 pt win in MIN. In their most recent meeting back in '19, the Ravens (-3') picked up an easy blowout win on MNF as QB Lamar Jackson threw for 5 TD's in the 45-6 win (BAL's 4th consecutive series win). Although this matchup is expected to be much closer this time around, we expect the Ravens (Jackson likely returning) to get the job done as they've gone a solid 7-3 ATS in recent HG's while the Rams are just 2-7-1 ATS vs AFC foes.

Cleveland at PITTSBURGH - MNF - The Browns saw their playoff hopes potentially dashed last Saturday in Lambeau against the Packers thanks to 4 int's thrown by Baker Mayfield (CLE 28-19 FD & 408-311 yd edges in a 2 pt defeat). The Steelers also look like they'll be sitting home after the regular season ends with KC's 26 pt win LW in Arrowhead moving PIT to just 7-7-1. In their 1st meeting of the season back on Halloween, the Steelers (+4') would overcome a 10-3 deficit in the 2H in an eventual 15-10 victory (PIT 370-306 yd edge). While the Steelers do own a commanding 18-5-1 run in recent matchups, also keep in mind that the Browns made a huge statement in their last trip to Heinz Field with a 48-37 victory in LY's WC meeting.
