KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Louisville over SYRACUSE - UL is 7-1 SU/ATS in this series and their average MOV is 31 ppg. Last year the Cardinals dominated Cuse 41-3, finishing with a 382-184 yard edge. Both teams come in with good experience returning. UL has 14 starters back while Cuse has 17, but the big match up edge is the Cardinals OLine which has 4 starters back after rushing for 210 (5.4) ypg last year while Cuse lost all 4 DLine starters from last year. QB Cunningham may not be asked to run as much with a deep backfield including returning RB's Mitchell (722, 4.7) and Cooley (431, 5.0) as well as Tennessee transfer Evans (525, 6.5). The Cardinals other big addition came at DT with Jermaine Lole (Ariz St) who brings great size and will be a big help defending All-American RB Sean Tucker. Cuse has a new OC in Robert Anae from Virginia who is going to install a more pass happy offense which may not fit the talents of QB Shrader. We see a lot of reasons to like Louisville here and call for the Cardinals to continue their series dominance!

FORECAST: Louisville by 13

3★ SAN DIEGO ST over Arizona Ariz leads all-time series 10-6, but LY was their 1st mtg since '01. SDSt was actually the dog LY (+1) but jumped out to a 35-7 HT lead (354-106) and won 38-14. Ariz HC Fisch enters year 2 and returns a fairly exp'd team with 15 st's back and they add Wash St QB de Laura along with former UTEP WR Cowden. SDSt loses their 1,000-yd rusher and their top 2 QB's, but they add former VTech QB Burmeister and still have a deep stable of productive RB's. They also return 7 st's from a DEF that all'd 324 ypg & 19.8 ppg LY. This is the 1st game for SDSt in their new stadium and the fans will be eager to see their team play a true home game after playing them 2 hours away the L2Y. Aztecs are also on a 6-2 SU/ATS run vs Pac-12 foes and we think they break open their new stadium with a strong win.

FORECAST: SAN DIEGO ST by 14

3★ EAST CAROLINA (+) over Nc State East Carolina has won 3 of the last 4 meetings but NCST did win the last meeting 34-6 (-17) in '19. The Wolfpack have 17 starters back from a 9-3 team that was +83 ypg last year but EC counters with 15 starters back after going 7-5 last year and had 3 close losses. Both teams have veteran QB's with Devin Leary (64%, 3433, 35-5) back for the Wolfpack while Holton Ahlers (62%, 3126, 18-10) returns for EC. The Wolfpack are just 5-10 SU/4-10-1 ATS on the road the last 3 years. EC led South Carolina 14-0 1Q last year and only lost on the final play of regulation. NCST does only have Charleston Southern next week so no look ahead here but they have high expectations and EC is a feisty dog. The home team has won & covered 5 of the last 6 which supports our lean as we only have NCST winning by a touchdown. **FORECAST: Nc State by 6**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ PITTSBURGH over West Virginia (Thursday) - The 105th Backyard Brawl meeting, but this is the first matchup since 2011! WVU has won 7 of the L/10 mtgs, but 4 of the L/5 were decided by 4 pts or less. Despite losing QB Pickett and WR Addison, Pitt returns 15 st's and they add QB Slovis from USC. WVU enters year 4 w/ Neal Brown & they return 7 st's on offense but just 4 on defense. WVU does add former USC/UGA QB Daniels and their DLine is one of the better ones in the B12. WVU has a stout OL as well, but Pitt counters with a top-notch DL that recorded 52 sks LY & returns 3 st's. Pitt enters this game with a huge exp edge (#32 vs #115) and HC Narduzzi enters 8-3 ATS the L3Y vs non-conf foes. Even with Tenn on deck, this is a rivalry game Pitt won't overlook & with the stronger team at home we see the Panthers winning by DD's. **FORECAST: PITTSBURGH by 13**

2★ INDIANA over Illinois (Friday) - 1st mtg since '17. The winning tm has covered 14 str in the series & IU has won & covered the L/3 matchups. ILL is off a 38-6 (-14) win over WY, in which they outgained the Cowboys 477-212 and had a 26-10 FD edge, but allowed 182 yds on the ground (5.9) to WY. ILL QB Devito (Syr transfer) went 27-37-194-2-0 and RB Brown ran for 156 (7.9) & 2 tds in the win, but #2 RB McRay did leave with a knee inj. Bielema is 19-14-1 as an AD, incl 4-1 LY, and ILL was 7-2 ATS in conf play LY. Season opener for IU & HC Allen has yet to publicly name a starting QB. Jack Tuttle (4 sts here) and Mizou transfer Bazelak (20 sts, 23-17 ratio) are battling for the job and should improve upon LY's QB performance (51%, 9-15 ratio). IU returns 7 st's on D and should be improved. IU is 3-2 SU (-1.4 ATS) in openers under Allen, but are 11-2 ATS as a HF during his tenure. They hold a large ST's edge over the Illini (#19 to #125). Despite ILL having a gm under their belt, we expect IU to get the win at home and move the series win/cover streak to 15 in a row. **FORECAST: INDIANA by 10**

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 1ST

TENNESSEE by 35 over Ball St - Year 2 of Josh Heupel in Knoxville kicks off. The Vols didn't cover last year's opener against a better than expected Bowling Green team who they beat 38-6 (-35). The Vols have a huge experience edge (#13 vs #122) with the Cardinals bringing back just 11 starters and must replace QB Plitt and 5 of their top 6 tacklers. Tenn has a huge offensive edge (#3 vs #124) and a big ST's edge as well (#10 vs #102). Hendon Hooker leads the Vols after throwing for 2,945 yards last year with a 31-3 ratio and is a darkhorse Heisman candidate but he isn't likely to be using his legs much with a big game vs Pitt on deck. The Vols are just 3-8 ATS in home openers. Ball St is facing their first SEC foe since 2015 when they lost to A&M 56-23 (+30). They are just 1-7 SU but 5-3 ATS in road openers. This Vols team is capable of scoring a lot of points but with a big game on deck we aren't confident they cover a 5 touchdown spread.

Penn St by 1 over PURDUE - 1st mtg since 2019. Last meeting Penn St won 35-7 (-28) in Happy Valley. Penn St has dominated the series, going 15-2 overall, incl winning the L/9 SU (6-3 ATS) and has won and covered L/4 on the road. Penn St is 6-2 SU & 4-4 ATS in openers under Franklin, incl a 16-10 (+5) upset win at WISC LY. PSU returns 7 st's on offense, with QB Clifford returning for 5th yr. Clifford had the Nittany Lions 5-0 LY before an inj vs Iowa and has 20 career sts under his belt. Purdue is 8-5 ATS as a HD under HC Brohm and is 6-0 SU (5-1 ATS) in their L/6 Big10 home openers, incl a 49-20 (+12) win over Ohio St '18. Both tms return their starting QBs, but Purdue has a slight experience edge, with 7 st's returning on both sides of the ball, incl QB O'Connell who threw for over 3700 yds w/a 28-11 ratio LY. Ross-Ade Stadium will be rocking for a night game, but we believe Penn St escapes with a close win.

MISSOURI by 22 over Louisiana Tech - First meeting. Missouri has won 16 straight home openers although last year they failed to cover as 2 td chalk against Central Mich, winning 34-24. LT nearly upset another SEC foe, Miss St, last year in their season opener. The Bulldogs were 23 pt dogs yet led 34-14 before allowing 3 straight td drives and lost by 1. The Tigers have 14 starters back from last year's 6-7 squad but are only #100 in experience. This is LT's first game under new HC Sonny Cumbie and they also have 14 starters back and are #86 in experience. Cumbie named UGA/TCU transfer Matthew Downing as the starting QB. The Bulldogs are 17-9-2 as an AD since '14 and were 11-7 ATS vs Power 5 foes under former HC Holtz? Can their new head coach carry that trend? Missouri has a big game with Kansas ST on deck but they won't look past the Bulldogs as they break open their brand new offense and look to get on a fast start.

MINNESOTA by 28 over New Mexico St - MINN 2-1 SU & ATS all-time vs NMSU, incl 48-10 (-21) win last mtg in '18. New Mexico St opened last week with a 23-12 home loss to Nevada, despite outgaining the Wolf Pack 303-257. The Aggies had 5 TO's, incl 4 int's. Starting QB Pavia threw 3 of the int's and was replaced by true frosh Frakes, who may end up getting the start here. New NMSU coach Kill was HC at Minn from 2011-2015 and led the Gophers to 3 winning ssns. Minn comes into this game on an 0-5 ATS slide vs FBS non-Power 5 foes incl an upset loss LY to Bowling Green.

NMSU has a game under their belt, but MINN returns 12 starters incl QB Morgan, who is looking to rebound from subpar ssn (10-9 ratio). His OC from '19 is back, which should provide a level of comfort. MINN 4-2 SU in openers with Fleck, but just 1-4-1 ATS. MINN should cruise to an easy victory, but Kill will do his best to keep it within the number against his former team.

OKLAHOMA ST by 17 over Central Michigan - 3rd meeting. Last met in 2016 where CMich (+20) pulled the upset 30-27 on the final play of the game. OSU enters '22 with 7 st's back on offense incl QB Sanders, 4 of the top 5 WR's and 4 OL. The OSU elite DEF from LY loses 7 st's, but their DLine is loaded with talent & is one of the tops in the nation. CMich also returns 7 st's on offense led by QB Richardson & the #1 FBS rusher LY RB Nichols. CMich does return just 4 DEF st's & they lose 6 of their top 8 tk'rs. OSU HC Gundy is 17-3 ATS since 2017 in non-conf games, but CMich is 6-4 ATS as an AD under HC McElwain and the Cowboys do have Ariz St on deck & were 0-2 ATS vs non-conf foes at home LY. We see OSU winning, but CMich getting the cover.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 2ND

Virginia Tech by 4 over OLD DOMINION - These in-state foes are separated by 283 miles and have met 3 times, with the home team winning all 3 times. ODU hosted VT back in '18 and scored 4 td's in 4Q to pull the upset 49-35 (+27). VT is under 1st year HC Brent Pry and they return just 4 st's on offense, but bring in Marshall QB Wells and bring back 7 st's on defense. ODU started just 1-6 LY but won 5 straight to get to a bowl & now return 17 st's (10 OFF/7 DEF) incl QB Wolff, TE Kuntz, 4 OL and 5 of the top 6 tk'rs. While there will be some VT fans in attendance, ODU fans will be ready and the Monarchs come into the game with a big experience edge (#20 vs #88). While we see VT coming away with the win, ODU will keep this game close.

MICHIGAN ST by 26 over Western Michigan - MSU won 51-17 (-15) in last meeting in '19. WM is 8-48 all-time vs B10 schools & just 2-14 vs MSU. WM only has 4 st's back on Off and lose LY's starting QB Eleby (22 car sts, 3277 yds & 23-6 ratio LY), who left early for the NFL and went undrafted. RFr Salopek is in line to get the start at QB. The Broncos return 7 st's from a D that allowed 331 ypg and 28.2 ppg. WM HC Lester is 0-4 SU/ATS vs Big10 Tms, losing by avg score of 43-12 and is just 3-7 as an AD. MSU only has 4 st's returning on off, but does return QB Thorne (3233 yds, 60.3%, 27-10 ratio) and top WR Reed (59-1026-17-4-0) from a squad that avg 429 ypg & 31.8 ppg. The Spartans return 9 st's on D & despite being dead last in pass yds allowed, they allowed just 25.3 ppg. HC Tucker expects better CB play and the unit should be improved overall. Tucker is 18-13-1 ATS as a HC, incl 12-7-1 here. The Spartans are 4-0 ATS vs non-conf foes under Tucker, who is 6-1 ATS vs non-conf as a HC. Sparty has clear edges on both sides of the ball & in ST's and should continue the Broncos trend of point spread losses to the B10.

DUKE by 10 over Temple - Duke was the only prior meeting in 2018 when the Blue Devils won the Independence Bowl 56-27. Both schools feature new head coaches rebuilding after 3-9 seasons. Duke has just 11 starters back. They lost their starting QB and all ACC 1,000 yard rusher Durant, along with 8 of their top 13 tacklers. Temple has 14 starters back but they finished last year on a truly sour note, losing their 7 by 34 ppg. Duke has made a living off beating non-power 5 foes. They are 21-2 SU at home vs Non-Conference foes since 2012 and 29-9 SU/ATS vs non-conference foes since 2013. Last year the Blue Devils did lose their opener at Charlotte but won their next 3 non-conference games. Temple was 0-5 as an AD last year. Duke HC Elko doesn't have a lot of winnable games on the schedule so in typical fashion we have Duke beating a weaker non-conference foe by DD's.

Tcu by 7 over COLORADO - First meeting. TCU is 4-0 SU in their L/4 meetings vs Pac 12 foes (3 bowls) and beat Cal 34-32 LY at home. CU left the B12 in 2010 and only has faced two B12 teams since then. CU is in year #3 under HC Dorrell and they bring back 12 st's. Their offense is led by QB Lewis, but they lose 5 of their top 7 tk'rs. TCU lost long-time HC Patterson LY and brought in HC Dykes from SMU. TCU brings back 10 st's on offense but still haven't settled on a starting QB, but they also return 8 st's on defense. TCU comes into this gm with the huge exp edge (#9 vs #75) and they only have a game as an FCS school on deck while CU has a matchup at Air Force looming next week. While we see TCU coming away with the win by a td, HC Dykes was just 3-10 ATS as road chalk at SMU.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 3RD

OLE MISS by 17 over Troy - Only other meeting between these schools was in 2013 where Miss gained 751 yds & won 51-21. Troy took down LSU (+20) 24-21 in 2017 and LY only lost to SCar 23-14. Miss returns 12 st's, but they added several Power 5 transfers incl QB Dart from USC and RB Evans from TCU. Troy brings back 9 st's on each side of the ball & they recently added former WVU QB Doege. However Troy has a new HC in Jon Sumrall, but he has some exp here as the LB cch from 2015-17. Troy enters with a significant edge in exp (#4 vs #118) and they have a stout pass rush. Miss has the talent edge to win this game, but they have a lot of new faces and we expect Troy to put up a fight as they have before on the road vs SEC foes.

Utah by 1 over FLORIDA - Florida is in a rare spot as an underdog in 'The Swamp' here. The Gators have only been dogs at home 3 times since 2018, covering all 3 including last year when they took Bama to the wire but missed a game tying 2 pt conversion. Utah is a trendy pick to contend for a playoff spot and come in ranked #7 in the AP Poll. The Utes have the experience edge (#62 vs #101) and Whittingham's teams thrive in their road openers, going 7-2 SU/7-1-1 ATS since 2013. Florida has 13 starters back after a 6-7 season. New HC Napier may have the perfect QB for his system in Anthony Richardson but most of his highlight plays last year came against USF and FAU. We think this is a much improved Florida squad, but beating a Top 10 team in their opener might be too big of a chomp for this new Gators squad. We are calling for a close game with the Utes pulled out a victory but the Gators staying close enough to cover.

Byu by 10 over SOUTH FLORIDA - The home team has won both prior matchups. USF is 2-0 ATS vs the Cougars, incl a 35-28 loss (+23) at BYU LY. The Bulls traded 28-6 at HT, but outscored BYU 21-7 in the 2H and pulled within 7 with 6 mins left, but never got the ball back. The Bulls did upset BYU 27-23 (+4) last time the tms met in Tampa in '19. Both schools return experienced squads, as USF returns 9 st's on both sides of the ball, while BYU has 8 st's back on offense and all 11 on D. USF is 5-1 ATS as HD under HC Scott, incl 4-0 LY. Baylor transfer QB Bohanon beat out LY's starter McClain for the starting job & McClain transferred late in the summer. The Bulls return their top 3 rushers and top 3 WRs. The D has moved to a 4-2-5 look under new DC Schoop and should improve upon the 471 ypg and 34.6 ppg allowed LY. BYU is coming off of 2 str double-digit win ssns under HC Sitake, who is 48-29 as HC of the Cougars. BYU returns QB Hall from an Off that avg 33.1 ppg LY, but they do lose 1600 yd rusher Allgeier. BYU went just 1-3 ATS as an AF LY and is 7-11 overall as AF under Sitake. BYU must deal with the heat and humidity of FL, which should allow USF to keep it within the line.

OHIO ST by 12 over Notre Dame - In regular season meetings Ohio St is 2-2 SU & 2-0 ATS vs Notre Dame but the last 2 meetings have been in the Fiesta Bowl with the Buckeyes winning & covering both. That includes the last meeting in the 2015 season when OSU won 44-28 as a 6' pt favorite. LTH (1995) #15 Notre Dame (+7) lost to #7 Ohio St 45-26. This is a tough first game for the Irish's new HC Marcus Freeman. Especially as he has to replace LY's 3000+ yd RB, 1000+ yd RB & top receiver (888 yd) but Notre Dame has the talent to reload and is still out #13 offense talent-wise but may need time to click. Ohio St has our #1 rated offense with three legitimate Heisman Candidates all returning in QB CJ Stroud (4435 yd), RB Trevon Henderson (1427) & WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba (1606). They both return 8 starters with Notre Dame having a slight edge (#6-#8). While the line has gone up, the Irish have won 5 straight road openers going 3-1-1 ATS and Ohio St has lost their last 2 home openers against ranked teams, losing to #5 Oklahoma 31-16 as a 7 pt HF in 2017 & to #12 Oregon 45-31 as a 14 pt HF last year. While we expect the Buckeyes to win, the Irish have the talent to keep it closer than the 2 td+ margin it has climbed to.

MARYLAND by 28 over Buffalo - 1st ever mtg. MD has won 16 straight home openers (10-3 ATS). Buffalo is 3-15 vs current Big Ten tms, but have gone 4-2 ATS vs B10 since 2013. UB 2nd yr HC Linquist went 4-8 (3-8-1 ATS) in his 1st ssn at the helm and only returns 9 str. Starting QB Vantrease transferred to GA Southern & they also lose their leading rusher from a yr ago. Cole Snyder, a SO transfer from Rutgers, will start at QB for the Bulls. UB was 0-4 as an AD LY & is just 4-12-1 as an AD since 2016. MD is coming off their 1st winning ssn since 2014 and returns 16 str, incl 9 from an offense that avg 29.3 ppg a yr ago. QB Tagovailoa is back after throwing for 3860 yds w/a 26-11 ratio. The Terps return 7 str on D and should be improved on that side of the ball. HC Locksley is 6-1 ATS vs non-conf at MD and the Terps are 8-5 ATS overall vs MAC foes, incl a 37-16 (-14) win over Kent St LY. The Terps experienced offense and improved D should be too much for a young Bulls squad that has struggled on the road.

MICHIGAN by 31 over Colorado St - Only prior meeting was the 1994 Holiday Bowl. CSU is just 1-12 SU all-time vs current Big 10 foes & despite being +23' pt dogs LY at lowa they only lost 24-14. Mich returns 9 str's on offense but will start QB McNamara here and then start QB McCarthy next week before determining a starter, and they return just 4 str's on defense. CSU brought in HC Norvell from Nev and he not only brings his Air Raid offense, he brought over several Nev players as well. CSU rFr Clay Millen will get his first career start in the Big House and Mich just has Hawaii on deck so they will not overlook this game. Mich is also 9-4 ATS in home openers since 2009 and were 6-1 ATS last season as a DD favorite. CSU should have a competitive squad in the MW this season, but staying close with Mich in the Big House is not something we see happening & Mich also has the edge in experience (#66 vs #110).

APPALACHIAN ST by 3 over North Carolina - 3rd mtg & first one at App St. Last meeting was back in 2019 at UNC where App St (+2) went up 27-10 2Q and blocked a FG on the final play of the game to pull the upset 34-31. UNC returns just 5 str's on offense and lose their QB and top 2 RB's, but return 8 str's on defense. App St's offense loses three 800+ yd WR's, but gets back QB Brice and their top 2 RB's who each ran for 900+ yds LY. App St's DEF returns just 5 str's & they lose the SBC DPOY. While there will be UNC fans at the game, Boone can be a tough place to play & they are 5-0 ATS in their last 5 games vs Power 5 foes. UNC does have a gm under their belt but it was just vs Fla A&M and this is a much tougher test for rFr QB Maye. Since '11 UNC is just 3-7-1 ATS in road openers & we see App St getting a big win in front of their home fans.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 6 over Rutgers - These two former Big East rivals last met in '19. The Eagles have won 11 straight over Rutgers (9-2 ATS). The Scarlet Knights last trip here was back in '04. Rutgers has 12 starters back from a 5-8 squad that was -86 ypg. BC has 13 starters back from a 6-6 squad that -25 ypg vs FBS foes. The big concern for the Eagles is keeping QB Jurkovec healthy which could be a tall task after losing 4 starting OL then their returning starter and the ACC's best OL, Christian Mahogany tore his ACL and is OFY so BC returns 0 OL starters. Rutgers has the experience edge #33 vs #72. The Scarlet Knights are 8-2 ATS on the road in Schiano's 2nd tenure. Rutgers is getting over a touchdown here and while we don't think they pull off the upset, we do think they keep it closer than expected.

JAMES MADISON by 3 over Middle Tennessee - Only other meeting came back in 1994 as FCS foes when MT was in the OVC and JMU won 24-22. MT is off a 7-6 season and they return just 5 starters on offense, led by QB Cunningham but they lose their top rusher and top 2 WR's. MT loses their top 4 tk'l's but return 6 str's on DEF. This is JMU's debut game as an FBS foe, but they bring back just 9 str's (5 Off/4 DEF) and lost several players in the offseason incl their QB, top WR and top tackler. JMU adds former Temple/CSU QB Centeio who brings veteran leadership & they will have the home crowd on their side. JMU is 21-1 SU under HC Cignetti in home games, but are just #112 in experience. This game seems very evenly matched and we'll take the home squad to win a close game.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 3 over Army - First meeting. CCU has gotten extra time to prep for the option and they also have experience facing it every season against GSthrn. Army returns 14 str's from a team that won 9 games incl a bowl last season. They return 3 of their top 4 rushers incl QB Tyler and 3 starting OL are back too. They do have to replace 5 of the top 8 tk'l's but they usually produce a quality DEF. CCU comes into the season losing their top rusher, top 3 receivers and 6 of the top 7 tk'l's on DEF. However they get back super QB McCall who led the FBS in pass eff last season & on DEF frosh AA DE Stewart (12.5 sk LY) is back. With both teams running a form of the option, the run game will be featured here and possessions will be limited. We see this being a close contest that the home team wins by a fg as they are 13-1 SU at home the L2Y.

KENTUCKY by 18 over Miami, Oh - KY won the last meeting in 2013 41-7. The 'Cats are 21-1 SU in home openers vs non Power 5 foes including last year when they beat ULM 45-10 (-31). The 'Cats have the experience edge (#77 vs #104) but they will be missing the SEC's top RB in Chris Rodriguez (Susp). QB Lewis has been getting mentioned as a possible first round draft choice next year. Miami was only #95 in pass D efficiency last year and they lost all 4 starting DB's. Kentucky has Florida on deck but HC Martin has notoriously not put as much focus into non-conference games, going 4-14 ATS since 2017. KY is on a 10-5 run as a home favorite so we can back the 'Cats here but they've only won their last 8 vs Group of 5 foes by 18 ppg which is coincidentally where we set our line.

SOUTH CAROLINA by 15 over Georgia St - First meeting. SC is 16-2 all-time vs Sun Belt foes but did lose their last meeting in '19 vs App State. Georgia St HC Sean Elliott is originally from South Carolina and coached here from '10-'16 including when he finished the '15 season as Interim HC. The Panthers have been a thorn in the side of SEC teams lately, beating Tennessee in '19's opener then nearly upset Auburn last year as 27' pt dogs. SC has 14 starters back and their big addition came at QB with Oklahoma transfer Spencer Rattler who just a year ago was a Heisman favorite entering last season. GAST has the experience edge (#3 vs #43) but we really like the job Shane Beamer did last year getting SC to 7-6. They do have Arkansas on deck but after seeing GAST nearly pull upsets over SEC foes we don't think SC falls for the trap and their huge ST's edge (#24 vs #131) could help the Gamecocks pull away in the 2nd half.

Smu by 6 over NORTH TEXAS - SMU has won & covered 6 of 7 meetings since since '14. Last year NT settled for 22 & 19 yard fg's and only led 6-0 despite a 228-87 yd edge. NT trailed 7-6 at half but allowed four td's in the 2nd half and lost 35-12 as a 22' pt dog but SMU only finished with

a 536-509 yard edge. NT led 14-13 at half last week then pulled away in the 2nd half to win by 18 at UTEP but yards were basically even as NT stopped UTEP on downs 4 times including at the NT1 and UTEP missed a fg. NT only forced 1 punt all game which could be an issue against SMU's offense which is led by Tanner Mordecai who threw for 3,628 (68%, 39-12). QB Aune threw for 236 and 3 td's. SMU is just 4-10 as an AF and they have a first year head coach in Rhett Lashlee while NT has a game under their belt and they've been traditionally a tough out in Apogee Stadium. The Mean Green are getting double-digits here so we like the dog.

OHIO by 1 over FAU - First meeting. FAU comes in with a game under their belt after beating Charlotte 43-13 (-7). The Owls actually trailed 7-0 1Q but quickly answered and a 63 yard pick 6 right by CLT's backup QB right before the half put FAU up 26-7. FAU has 14 starters back including QB Perry who threw for 256 yards last week. Ohio looks to bounce back off a disappointing 3-9 season. Their offseason was much smoother than last year when Frank Solich retired less than 2 months prior to their opener. The Bobcats have 14 starters back as well including QB Rourke and their top 4 tacklers. The Owls were 0-4-1 ATS when off a SU win last year. This is a must win for Ohio with road trips to Penn St and Iowa St on deck. We are calling for the Bobcats to avoid an 0-3 start by pulling a small upset here.

Tulsa by 10 over WYOMING - Teams have split their 6 previous meetings. WY's first time hosting Tulsa since 1994. Last meeting was in '19 where WY led 7-0 early, then came back to lead 21-17 4Q but lost 24-21. Tulsa loses a 1,000-yd WR and a 1,000-yd RB on offense but returns QB Brinn and overall return 12 str's. WY is off an 38-6 loss at Illinois where they were held to just 212 total yards (only 30 pass yards) while they allowed 477 yds incl 260 rush (6.3). WY lost several key players from LY's team to the portal and will be a work in progress as they work in several new & lesser exp'd players. WY does have the advantage of playing in the altitude and they are 3-1 ATS since 2019 as home dogs. However Tulsa is 5-1 ATS as an AF under HC Montgomery since 2019 and we think they go into WY and come away with the win & cover.

USC by 28 over Rice - These two haven't met since 1971 but HC Bloomgren is plenty familiar with the Trojans from his time at Stanford. USC has won their last 5 home openers but are just 1-4 ATS in those. HC Lincoln Riley made quite a splash in the offseason, leaving Oklahoma and bringing QB Caleb Williams and WR Mario Williams with him, plus adding Biletnikoff winner Jordan Addison from Pitt. Rice had a misleading final score in their opener last year when they went to Ark and led 17-7 3Q but lost by 21 (+20). Bloomgren likes to play ball control and slow the game down which could help them keep this closer than expected. The public will undoubtedly back the Trojans here, and it's worth noting that Riley won his first game as HC at Oklahoma 56-7 over UTEP, but that was a smoother transition as Riley had been promoted from OC for the Sooners and UTEP went on to finish 0-12. Riley has only covered 2 of his last 7 vs FBS foes as 30+ chalk. USC has Stanford on deck and we think Rice does enough to stay within the line as a 5 touchdown underdogs.

UCLA by 20 over Bowling Green - First meeting. UCLA's only prior game vs a "then" MAC foe was a 30-21 win over Temple as a 4' pt favorite in 2009. Bruins are 17-5 SU (13-9 ATS) in Home openers but are just 2-2 SU & ATS under HC Chip Kelly but easily covered vs Hawaii last year winning 44-10 as a 17' pt HF. The Falcons are 0-3 vs current P12 teams including a 58-24 loss at #24 Oregon in 2018 as a 33 pt AD. The Falcons have dropped 6 straight road openers with their only cover being at Tenn LY as they "only" lost 38-6 as a 35 pt AD. Both teams have FCS foes on deck so there should be no look ahead for UCLA. Still, BG upset Minnesota 14-10 LY as a 21 pt AD and returns 18 starters from LY's team. UCLA on the other hand lost 40-37 to Fresno St last year as an 11 pt HF and returns just 8 starters including just 2 on defense. This is BG HC Loeffler's best team as he has built it with all his recruits, and they should take a step up this year. While we don't expect an outright upset here the Falcons are quite capable of keeping within 3 td's and are getting over that here.

Boise St by 4 over OREGON ST - OSU leads the series 5-4 SU but since 2003 BSU is 4-2-1 ATS and in their last meeting in 2016 here Boise (-13') won 38-24 (+225 yds). OSU brings back 15 str's incl 9 on defense and QB Nolan. Last season Boise won just 7 games, their lowest total since 1998! This season the Broncos return 17 str's incl QB Bachmeier, RB Holani, 4 OL and 9 on defense are back as well as 13 of the top 15 tk'l's. OSU went 6-0 SU/ATS last season in home games, while Boise St was 5-1 ATS last season in road games incl upsets of ranked BYU and Fresno St last season. Boise will want to bounce back from LY and we think they start the season off with a key road win against a solid Beavers team.

WASHINGTON by 24 over Kent St - First meeting. Washington is 3-0 all-time vs MAC teams outscoring them by a combined 149-7 but the last game was a 48-0 win over MAC member Toledo in 1991. Kent St is 0-2 vs current P12 teams being outscored by a combined 72-7 but covered as a 24' pt AD in their last game losing to Arizona St 30-7 in 2019's season opener. Washington is the more exp'd team returning 13 starters including 8 on offense led by QB Dylan Morris (2459 yd). The Flashes return just 10 starters including just 4 on offense & must replace their star QB Dustin Crum (3187 yd) but do return their top 2 RB's who combined for over 2000 yds. Kent St has covered 3 of 4 road openers under HC Sean Lewis and came up just short last year losing 41-10 at Texas A&M as a 29' pt AD. Still Washington is coming off a disappointing 4-8 season including a 13-7 loss to FCS Montana in LY's home opener as a 22 pt HF. KSU has a brutal opening schedule as 2 of their next 3 games are at Oklahoma & Georgia. We look for HC Lewis to try to keep his team healthy through that gauntlet, especially his new QB. This is new HC Kalen DeBoer's first game and with an FCS foe on deck there will be no look ahead. We think he will keep his foot on the gas here & get the cover.

Texas St by 1 over NEVADA - Only prior meeting was in 2012 at TXSt when these teams were both in the WAC & Nev won 34-21 despite trailing 21-20 at HT. TXSt is just 1-8 all-time vs current MW foes, but this looks like HC Spavital's best team yet. TXSt returns 14 str's incl 9 on offense led by RB Hill and WR's Banks & Barbee plus they add former Ark St QB Hatcher (7,427 yds, 65-25 ratio in 3Y at Ark St). DEF will be the key for TXSt as they have never all'd less than 32.6 ppg under Spavital. Nev won last week at NMST despite being outgained by 46 yds, but were helped out by a +5 TO margin. Nev ran the ball 45 times while passing just 23 so look for more of that here. TXSt rates the edge in exp (#57 vs #131) and we look for an exp'd QB in Hatcher to lead the TXSt offense against a Nev team that struggled last week to move the ball against one of the worst tms in the country.

GEORGIA by 20 over Oregon - The defending National Champion Bulldogs face their former DC Dan Lanning in his first game as Head Coach of Oregon. The Bulldogs have the tall task of replacing 15 drafted players including 9 on their historic defense that allowed just 10.2 ppg and 269 ypg. Naturally they are reloading with more talented players and the offense brings back 7 starters. Oregon has the experience edge with 15 starters back and they added Auburn transfer Bo Nix who started 3 games vs Georgia, completing 54% with a 1-2 ratio. Nix had just a 15-14 ratio and was 6-9 as a starter on the road at Auburn. This 'Neutral Site' game is being played at Mercedes Benz Stadium in Atlanta so there will be plenty of Red and Black in the crowd. Lanning knows the personnel and the Ducks have a talented squad so we can only go with a slight lean on the Bulldogs.

ALABAMA by 38 over Utah St - Talk about a step up in competition for Utah St, going from lowly UConn to Bama! The Crimson Tide opens the season at home for the first time since 2011 after playing 9 Neutral Site openers and in the Covid year they opened at Missouri. Bama has won 20 straight season openers. The last meeting was in '05 when Bama won 35-3 (-34). Utah St found themselves down 14-0 1Q vs UConn last week but quickly recovered and led by 10 at half with a 343-234 yard edge. Bama actually has a slight experience edge (#52 vs #65) and they return Heisman winning QB Bryce Robinson (67%, 4872, 47-7) and Nagurski winner OLB Will Anderson (17.5 sk LY). The Aggies don't stand a chance but we don't think Bama runs it up with a trip to Texas on deck but they sure can't afford another slow start.

Over 40 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years **INCLUDING 4 MORE OUTRIGHT UPSET WINNERS IN 2021!!!** Here is This week's Underdog Play:

SOUTHERN MISS +3' over Liberty

LU won the only prior meeting 56-35 as 13-pt home chalk in 2020. LU enters 2022 with 11 ret st'rs, but lost QB Willis to the NFL and they also lose 7 of their top 11 tk'l'rs. They do add veteran QB Charlie Brewer and return their top 2 WR's. SMiss is looking for a bounce back season this year after going 3-9 last year and suffering several injuries to key players. SMiss returns 16 starters led by QB Keyes, RB Gore and WR Brownlee on offense while the DEF returns their top 10 tk'l'rs, but they did lose star LB Maples for the season. SMiss enters this game with a huge edge in exp (#6 vs #84) and will want to start the season off right in front of their home fans, while LU was just 1-3 ATS as an away dog last season and now are without their dynamic, playmaking QB. We'll call for SMiss to pull the outright upset at home.

FORECAST: SOUTHERN MISS by 4

OKLAHOMA by 24 over Utep - OU has won the previous 4 mtgs all by 17+ pts. Last met in the '17 opener & OU went up 35-7 HT (419-95) and won 56-7. UTEP played last week vs NTexas, and despite the yds being nearly even (UTEP 400-399 edge) they lost 31-13 as they missed an early FG, turned it over on downs 4 times, and were held to a FG in the RZ after a turnover. This is OU HC Venables 1st game and the Sooners lost a lot of talent to the portal, most notably QB's Rattler & Williams. However they add former UCF QB Gabriel who is reunited with OC Lebby. UTEP has the edge in exp (#7 vs #90) but OU's talent is far superior, they just haven't gotten the in-game reps. OU was just 2-5 ATS as DD chalk last season and with UTEP having a game under their belt and the line being over 4 td's, we think UTEP can stay within the large point spread.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 17 over Memphis - Last year Miss St dominated this game statistically, finishing with a 468-246 yard edge but lost 31-29. The big swing came on a punt that appeared to be downed when a Memphis player picked it up and ran 94 yards for a td. Memphis also had a 49 yard fumble return td. Miss St has 17 starters back with one of the top defenses in the SEC after bringing back 11 of their top 14 tacklers from a unit that gave up 25.9 ppg and 345 ypg. The Bulldogs have the experience edge (#8 vs #55) and QB Rogers is back after throwing for 4,739 (74%, 36-9). The Tigers have 13 starters back from a team that only went 6-6 last year. HC Leach is just 1-4 as a HF here but he is 48-38-2 as a HF in his career and HC Silverfield is 0-8 ATS on the road with 4 losses by double-digits. This is Leach's 3rd year at Miss St and we think the revenge minded Bulldogs take care of business by more than 2 touchdowns.

TEXAS by 28 over Ulm - ULM is winless (0-12 SU) vs current Big 12 foes. Only prior mtg for these tms came back in 2009 when Texas won 59-20 (+264 yds). ULM is in year 2 under veteran HC Terry Bowden, who was able to lead the Warhawks to 4 wins last season. ULM returns 12 st'rs with 8 those on offense led by QB Rogers and WR Knight. The Warhawks do return just 4 st'rs on DEF and their secondary is the least exp'd unit of the defense. Texas landed former Ohio St QB Ewers, who won the job and they are led by arguably the top RB in the country Bijan Robinson. Texas did lose a starting WR and OL to inj before the season but still have a talented squad overall. While ULM has lost their L/10 games vs Power 5 foes by an average of 34 ppg, they are facing a Texas team that is surely looking ahead to their home matchup against Alabama next week. ULM covered 5 gms LY as a DD dog incl at LSU (+29, lost 27-14). Texas should win the game easily, but will likely pull starters in 2H if up big, and the line is currently over 5 td's.

ARKANSAS by 4 over Cincinnati - First meeting. Cincy is coming off a playoff season where they had 8 players drafted so there is naturally a concern about the loss of talent. Arkansas only has 11 starters back and only has a slight experience edge (#83 vs #103). HC Pittman is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS vs non-conference foes but last year they actually trailed Rice in their opener 17-7 3Q before turnovers led to a 21 point win. The Bearcats lost 27-6 vs Bama last year in the Playoffs while Arkansas trailed Bama by 14 before scoring a td with 1:02 left to lose 42-35 (+20). Arkansas has a strong run game but must replace WR Treyton Burks who had nearly 700 yards more than last year's #2. Fickell is 8-4 as an away dog and we think he will have this team better than expected so we expect a close game.

Houston by 3 over UTSA - 1st mtg since 2014. Series is tied at 1-1. UTSA enters on a 10 gm home win streak. Both tms are coming off 12-2 ssn. HOU returns 13 st'rs, including QB Tune who threw for 3544 yds w/a 30-10 ratio LY. They did lose leading rusher McCaskill to an ACL, but return their top receiver. The D allowed just 20.4 ppg & had 45 sks and return 10 of the top 12 DL. HC Holgorsen is 4-4 as an AF at HOU & 6-5 ATS against non-conf foes here. UTSA has 8 returning st'rs on Off and 5 on Def. QB Harris made all 14 sts LY and was 2nd Tm All-Conf, throwing for 3177 w/a 27-6 ratio & was also the 2nd leading rusher (109-698-5.2). The Roadrunners only

While these teams were a combined 3-21 last year, they had very different seasons as Tulane only lost 40-35 to then #2 Oklahoma as a 32 pt AD & then 31-12 to then #2 Cincy as a 27' pt HD, finishing the season with 3 losses by 7 pt or less & a 45-14 win over USF. UMass' only win was over a UConn team who's only win was by 20-15 over Yale. They also lost by 13 & 25 to 2 FCS foes and had 5 losses by 38+ pts. While the Minutemen return 16 starters (8 on both sides) Tulane returns 18 (9 of both side). Tulane also has a 7th year HC who had 3 straight non-losing seasons before last year. UMass brings back former HC Don Brown but this is his first year back and he must try to fit the players he inherited to his new systems, which will take some time. The last 2 times the Green Wave were a favorite of over 3 td's under HC Fritz were both in 2016 and Tulane covered both those game and we expect them to do it again here as they start the season. Tulane is 10-2 as a home favorite while UMass is 4-16-1 as an AD, making this our technical play of the week.

Wku by 21 over HAWAII - First meeting. 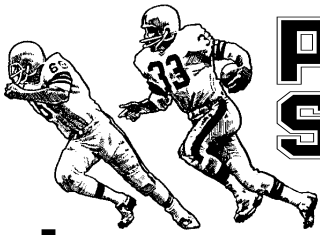
