4★ VIRGINIA TECH over Purdue - Purdue is making their first trip to Blacksburg. 'Enter Sandman' was rockin last week as the Hokies cashed both a 4★ top Power Sweep play and a 4★ LPS, beating Old Dominion 36-17 (-16). Grant Wells threw 3 td passes and now he faces a Purdue defense that allowed 371 pass yds at home to Fresno St last week. Purdue (-3) led Fresno St 28-17 3Q last week but the offense struggled and they gave up the go-ahead score with :59 left, as we dropped our 4★ LPS on the Boilermakers. Purdue was outgained 487-363 and out FD'd 27-19. We have VT with a big ST edge but Purdue did have a KR td last week. VT also has the experience edge (#65 vs #112) and this will be Purdue's first road game under HC Walters. We also think the Hokies have the edge on defense, ST's, coaching and they are at home so we call for VT to start 2-0 and will go back to Blacksburg for our top Power Sweep play!

FORECAST: VIRGINIA TECH by 10 over Purdue

3★ ALABAMA over Texas - This is Texas' first trip to Tuscaloosa since 1902! Bama's non-conference regular season win streak is now at 56 but nearly came to an end last year at Texas when Bama needed a fg with :10 left to win 20-19 (-21). The Tide are 13-2-1 ATS in non-conference Power-5 games. The Longhorns were clearly looking ahead to this game last week as they only beat Rice 37-10 (-35') though they did have a 458-176 yd edge & 24-8 FD's. Quinn Ewers played well prior to suffering an injury last year but this time he has to deal with a hostile crowd. Texas lost two of their true road games last year, at OKSt and Texas Tech. Jalen Milroe got the start for Bama last week vs Middle Tenn and threw for 194 (3 td's) and ran for 48 (2 td's). The Tide scored 14 points in each quarter and won 56-7 (-39). Texas is 0-3 as an away dog under Sarkisian. Bama's road struggles are well documented but their 13-5-1 record as home chalk gives us confidence that the Crimson Tide will win by double-digits.

FORECAST: ALABAMA by 15

3★ Wisconsin over WASHINGTON ST - These teams met last year in Madison and the Cougars pulled off a huge upset as they beat the Badgers 17-14 (+17) despite being outgained 401 to 253. The Luke Fickell era at Wisconsin got off to a little bit of a slow start as the Badgers (-28) only led Buffalo 14-10 at HT. The Badgers turned things up in the 2H, sparked by an 89 yd TD run by Chez Mellusi. He finished with 157 (12.1) and Braelon Allen also topped the century mark (144, 8.3) as Wisconsin rolled up 314 rush yds (7.8). Washington St opened their '23 season with a dominant win at Colorado St in which they outgained the Rams 556-357. Colo St scored the first 3 points, then the Cougs scored 36 unanswered points and led 36-3 in the 4Q. Wazzu QB Cam Ward threw for 451 and 3 scores and was also the leading rusher (40, 3.1) The Cougs D forced 2 TO's and held the Rams to just 37 (1.8) rush yards. Washington St is 5-2 as a HD the L2Y, but Wisconsin has edges in all 3 phases and has revenge on their mind so we'll side with the Badgers to win and cover in Pullman.

FORECAST: Wisconsin by 13

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ MISSISSIPPI ST over Arizona - Miss St won the first meeting last year on the road, 39-17 (10') but they did only lead 25-17 4Q and got SOD's at the MS23, 31 & 6 on AZ's final 6 possessions. The Bulldogs weren't very impressive in their win over FCS SELA last week. They only led 3-0 after 1Q, 20-7 at half. They pulled away after a blocked punt td to win 48-7 (-28). AZ only led FCS Northern Arizona 14-3 at half but did have a 263-100 yd edge and won 38-3 (-28). MSU has the experience edge (#32 vs #97) but the Bulldogs are a different team under HC Zach Arnett who is switching their offense from the Air Raid to a more balanced attack. AZ did cover as double-digit dogs at Washington and beat #9 UCLA on the road last year. The Wildcats return QB de Laura, their top 3 RB's and 1,000 yd WR Jacob Cowing. The defense is a work in progress with just 3 starters back and Miss St put up 525 yards and 23 FD's last week. RB Jo'Quavious Marks rushed for 127 and they also used athletic Vandy transfer QB as a change of pace, rushing for 95 yds. The Bulldogs have a huge edge on defense (#24 vs #116) and are laying single-digits here! **FORECAST: MISSISSIPPI ST by 15**

2★ UTSA over Texas St - UTSA is 4-0 all-time against Texas St and 3 of the 4 games have been decided by 7 points or less incl the last meeting in 2020 as UTSA led 24-7 HT but Texas St came back to tie the game 41-41 and UTSA won 51-48 in 2OT. UTSA has a big edge in experience (#13 vs #125) but TXSt got their 1st win vs a Power 5 school as they shockingly pulled the upset over Baylor LW, winning 42-31 (+27') despite being -83 yds as QB Finley threw for 298 yds & 3 td's! UTSA is off a 17-14 loss at Houston despite being +83 yds as QB Harris threw 3 int's. Texas St offense looks good under new HC Kinne, who was coached by UTSA HC Trawler is HS, but Texas St defense could be a work in progress. UTSA does have Army on deck, but after losing LW won't look past Texas St here and we expect them to rebound at home and win by over 2 td's and think we are getting great line value on this game. **FORECAST: UTSA by 17**

KANSAS at Illinois - 1st meeting since 1968. Illinois is on an 0-4 ATS run in road openers. The Illini are off a 30-28 (-9') home win over Toledo despite being outgained 416-374. New starting QB Luke Altmyer threw for 211 (%) and led a 12 play 65 yard drive for a game-winning FG with 5 secs left. Kansas hasn't faced a B10 team since 2018 and is 2-1 SU (3-0) vs B10 foes since 2008. The Jayhawks opened their season with an 48-17 (-31') win over FCS Missouri St, although they did only lead 17-10 at HT. QB Jalon Daniels did not play (back) and backup Jason Bean threw for 276 and 2 tds and the Jayhawks defense held the Tigers to just 217 total yds. Kansas has a huge experience edge in this one as they are #1 on our Experience Chart, while Illinois is just #116. The Jayhawks were 4-0 ATS vs non-conference foes last year and the Illini have their B10 opener vs Penn St on deck. Call 1-800-654-3448 to get our Friday Night Marquee for just \$12.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 9TH

WAKE FOREST by 9 over Vanderbilt - Last year WF led 35-10 when Vandy QB AJ Swann came off the bench and threw 2 td passes but the Deacons won 45-25 (-13'). The visitor is 4-1 SU/5-0 ATS since 2010. Vandy led Hawaii 35-14 4Q in their opener then allowed two td drives and won by just 7. They had a slow start last week, only leading 12-3 at half but won 47-13 (-36) over Alabama A&M. WF Elon 27-0 3Q, allowed a 76 yd td drive and a pick 6. Elon also tacked on a fg on the final play as WF won 37-17 (-31). The Deacons have just 11 starters back from last year while Vandy has 15 starters back and are in their 2nd year under HC Clark Lea. WF QB Mitch Griffis has started two games but both came against FCS foes while AJ Swann started 6 games including roadies at Bama and Georgia so he won't be intimidated. WF is on an 11-4 run as a HF but Lea is 7-3 as an away dog. The Commodores will keep this game within 2 td's.

Notre Dame by 11 over NC STATE - These two have met 3 times since 2002, with NCSt winning in '02 & '16 but ND won 35-14 (-7) in '17. The Irish have a big step up in competition after dominating Navy 42-3 (-20) and Tennessee ST 56-3 (-48) Sam Hartman looks like an early Heisman candidate, completing 82.5% of his passes and has a 6-0 ratio. He faces a familiar foe in NCSt who intercepted Hartman 3 times in both '21 and '22 when he played for Wake Forest but he's in a different offense now. Hartman lost 2 of the 3 games he started against NCSt. The Wolfpack

enters with extra rest after beating UConn 24-14 (-14'). The Pack only had a 364-320 yd edge. Virginia transfer Brennan Armstrong is back with OC Robert Anae who he flourished with in '21. He ran for 96 yards and 2 td's and threw for 155 at UConn. NCSt has covered their last 3 as underdogs but ND is fresh after two easy wins. Hartman looks locked in right now and ND is 12-4-1 as an away favorite. We have the Irish winning by double-digits.

SYRACUSE by 30 over Western Michigan - The Orange are 2-0 SU & ATS vs the Broncos. SYRACUSE is a 52-33 win as 4' pt HF in their last meeting in 2019. Both of those meetings have been high scoring events as the teams combined for 97 in '18 and 85 in '19. Both are off wins over FCS foes. Syracuse dominated Colgate 65-0 (despite a scoreless 4Q) as a 37 pt HF finishing with a 677-106 yd edge. WM beat St Francis 35-17 as a 14 pt HF finishing with a 509-281 yd edge. Syracuse has a huge experience edge onto only on the field (#35-#118) but also have an 8th year Head Coach while WM is under in not only under a new HC but this is just HC Lance Taylor's 2nd ever game as a HC and first time on the road. The Orange have the edge on both Offense (#48-#131) & on Defense (#48-#131) and we look for them to dominate the inexp'd Broncos here & Syracuse HC Babers is 7-2 ATS as 20+ pt chalk here.

GEORGIA by 40 over Ball St - First meeting. UGA plays their 2nd straight warm up game before the real competition starts next week vs South Carolina. The Bulldogs had several players missing last week including 2 of their top 3 RB's, their top 2 WR's and All SEC LB Smael Mondon was limited. That partly explains the lackluster start, only leading UT Martin 17-0 at half. While UGA did pull away to win 41-7 (UTM gbg td on final drive), we have to think HC Smart will want the Bulldogs to put forth a better effort with their SEC opener on deck. Ball St led Kentucky 7-3 2Q last week but they lost their star LB Clayton Coll to a leg injury and the 'Cats pulled away in the 2H. Ball St was covering until KY added a 30 yd td with :06 left, losing 44-14 (+25'). BSU is 10-6 as an away dog but they have a more winnable game on deck. UGA is now 1-10 as a non-conference favorite of 35+ points. We figure the Dawgs will empty the bench with walk-ons in the 2nd half, giving us a small lean on the underdog.

Marshall by 3 over EAST CAROLINA - 17th meeting. Last met in '21 where MU (-10) led 24-21 HT and 38-21 3Q before ECU scored 21 straight pts 4Q and comeback to win 42-38. MU is off close 21-17 win vs Albany where they trailed 17-7 3Q and QB Fancher threw for 268 (80%) while ECU lost 30-3 vs Michigan in the 'Big House' last week. This season MU brings back 11 st'rs with 7 of those being on offense led by QB Fancher who is a great dual-threat QB and they also get a full season of RB Ali (1401 yds '21) who only played 3 gms LY & ran for 137 (7.6) last wk. ECU comes into this season #121 in experience and just 10 starters as they are breaking in a new QB and lost their top RB & top 3 WR's on offense. These teams rate fairly evenly on both offense and defense but MU HC Huff is an impressive 9-3 ATS on the road here and MU has a bye on deck so their full focus will be on this game wanting to improve off last wk's subpar showing & we see the Herd coming away with a close road win.

PITTSBURGH by 14 over Cincinnati - Pitt has won 8 of 12 mtgs vs Cincy but last one came in '12 when both teams were in the Big East and Cincy won 34-10. Pitt is off a win vs Wofford 45-7 while Cincy took care of business vs E.Kentucky 66-13 where new QB Emory Jones scored 7 total td's. Cincy comes into '23 just #128 in experience as they return just 9 st'rs, move into the Big 12, have a new HC and lose their top RB and top 8 WR's! The strength of Cincy is their DLine but they face a Pitt offense that is led by BC transfer QB Jurkovec and overall rank #44 in offense entering the season while Cincy comes in at #79. Both teams do have rivalry games on deck and while Pitt HC Narduzzi is just 14-22-2 as a home favorite including 2-4 ATS LY, however Cincy looks like they are in for a rebuild year and Pitt has the overall talent edge and we feel like they will pull away and win this game by 2 touchdowns.

James Madison by 3 over VIRGINIA - These two in-state schools haven't met since 1983. Virginia enters as the underdog and may be playing without their starting QB Tony Muskett, who left last week's 49-13 (+27') loss vs Tennessee with a shoulder injury. The 'Hoos were also playing w/o starting DE Chico Bennett (7 sk LY). Their backup QB was supposed to be Jay Woolfolk but he quit to focus on baseball so they are left with true frosh Anthony Colandrea who threw for 12 yards on 7 attempts in mop-up duty last week. Last year JMU lost to ACC foe Louisville 34-10 (+7) but they were worn down by then. Last week JMU was outgained 204-187 in the 1H vs FCS Bucknell but dominated the 2H (249-21 yd edge) and won 38-3 (-42). JMU last beat a P5 in 2010 when they upset V.Tech. The Dukes are in a rare spot as a road favorite vs a Power-5. UVA does have a solid defense and will put up a fight at home so we only give JMU a 3 point lean.

COLORADO by 7 over Nebraska - These teams met every year from 1948 through 2010, but have only met twice since ('18 & '19). Nebraska leads the all-time series 49-20-2. The Huskers lost 13-10 (+7) at Minnesota last week in new HC Matt Rhule's debut and are now 2-14 in one-score games since 2021. Rhule had the NEB "Blackshirt" defense up to the challenge, as they limited the Gophers to 251 total yards, including just 55 (2.2) on the ground. Husker QB Jeff Sims rushed for a team-high 91 (4.8), but threw 3 costly ints including 1 in the EZ at the end of the 1H and 1 in MIN territory on a potential game-winning drive, which led to the Gophers' game-winning FG as time expired. Colorado opened the "Coach Prime" era with a bang as they pulled the outright upset over TCU 45-42 (+20'). The Buffaloes outgained the Frogs 565-541 as QB Shedeur Sanders went 38-47 for 510 yds and 4 tds. Colorado had 4 receivers top the 100 yd mark, incl 2-way standout Travis Hunter (11-119). Coach Prime has been pointing to this game and they should have a sell-out crowd in Boulder and we'll ride the emotional wave and take the Buffs by a td.

Utah by 4 over BAYLOR - First mtg. Baylor is at home for the 2nd straight week but are off an upset vs Texas St, as they lost 42-31 as 27' pt chalk! Utah is off a 24-11 win vs Florida despite QB Rising missing the game (check status) but they were outgained by 76 yards and were out FD'd 17-14. Baylor brings back 12 st'rs but come into the season #84 in experience while Utah is #28. Utah also rates the edge on defense (#6 vs #76) as they have 9 st'rs back on that side of the ball while Baylor has 5 and they just allowed 441 yds to TXSt last wk. Baylor went just 1-4 ATS last season against ranked teams, but will fight hard to avoid an 0-2 start. However Rising playing would make a difference here in a hostile environment but QB Barnes looked solid last week we still think regardless of Rising's staus that the Utes come away with a close win and Baylor QB Shapen was banged up last week (knee) and his status is ? for Saturday and bkp QB Robinson would be in line to start.

Oklahoma St by 8 over ARIZONA ST - 5th meeting all-time. Last met just a seasons ago and Okla St (-11') led 17-3 HT, but ASU cut it to 20-17 4Q before Okla St scored 2 4Q td's to win & cover 34-17 (Okla St +111 yds). Oklahoma St is off a 27-13 win vs Central Arkansas while ASU only beat Southern Utah 24-21 (led 21-7 HT) in a game that was delayed nearly 3 hrs due to weather. ASU brings back 13 st'rs this season, but true frosh Jaden Rashada started at QB & threw for 236 (58%, 2-0). Oklahoma St is just #115 in experience as they lose their QB, top RB and 4 of top 5 WR's from last year, and last week 3 different QB's played last week. Oklahoma St does have the coaching edge with Gundy (19th ssn) vs Dillingham (1st ssn) and the Cowboys also have the edge on defense (#65 vs #107) and their DLine & LB's are strong. Gundy is on a 7-3 ATS run as an away favorite since '19 and we feel like the Cowboys will win by just over td.

Eastern Michigan +19' over MINNESOTA

Eastern Michigan (+) over MINNESOTA - 1st meeting. EMU is just 3-39 vs current B10 teams, but have gone 4-4 SU and 6-2 ATS vs Power 5 teams the L6Y, including 3 wins over B10 squads. The Eagles opened their season with a 33-23 (-24) win over FCS Howard, despite being outgained 398-285. EMU led 30-9 at HT, but allowed the Bison to pull within a TD late in 3Q before kicking a fg with 4 mins left to push their lead to 10. The Eagles managed just 110 rush yds (3.7), while allowing 204 (4.9). Minnesota came away with a 13-10 (-7) comeback win over Nebraska in their season opener. The Gophers managed just 251 total yds, but forced 4 Huskers TO's including an int late 4Q that led to their game-winning fg as time expired. Gophers HC Fleck is 13-11 ATS as a HF here 24-6 since '16. The Eagles are a staple for our Underdog Play of the Week and we don't mind going back to them yet again!

LIBERTY by 10 over New Mexico St - Last year both were Independents but this will be the first Conference game for both as new members of CUSA. New Mexico St has dropped 7 straight road openers (2-5 ATS) ans after playing their first 2 at home make the over 1,500 mile trip here. Teams met here LY with the Flames distracted from rumors of their HC Hugh Freeze leaving, which he did 2 days after the game. The Aggies shocked the Flames 49-14 as a 24' ptAD despite only a 428-315 yard edge as they had three td's of over 39 yards. LW the Aggies beat up on a weak FCS team 58-21 as an 18 pt HF taking out their frustrations after being upset by UMass 41-30 as a 7 pt HF in their season opener. Liberty is off a 34-24 win over Bowling Green as a 8 pt HF where they intercepted five passes. The Aggies have the edge on offense (#73-#99) but the Flames have the edge on defense (#101-#129) and may be looking for some revenge here but with the line pushing 2 td's we will lean slightly with the road dog in this game.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC by 3 over Ohio - These teams met last year for the 1st time and OU came away with a 41-38 (+4) home win as FAU was stopped on downs with :32 left. The Bobcats enter this one at 1-1 SU/ATS and are off a 27-10 (-38) win over FCS Long Island as Ohio held the Sharks to just 206 total yds. The Bobcats played without starting QB Nathan Rourke (CS) and backups CJ Harris and Parker Navarro combined for just 104 pass yds. OU did rush for 199 (4.4) but didn't pull away from LIU until the 3Q. FAU won their season opener 42-20 (-21) over FCS foe Monmouth. QB Casey Thompson (Texas/Neb transfer) went 20-25 for 280 yds and 5 tds in HC Tom Herman's FAU debut. The Owls amassed 493 yds total yds, incl 125 rush from all-conf RB Larry McCammon. Herman was just 10-20-1 ATS as a HF at his previous coaching stops and while we think the Owls get revenge for last year's loss, we like the Bobcats to keep this one within the line.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 12 over Uab - Only prior meeting was LY at UAB where the Blazers (-12) led 21-7 HT but GS cut it to 28-21 4Q before UAB tacked on a td for the cover 35-21. Last week UAB won 35-6 over NC A&T as QB Zeno was 38-41 passing & 13 different players caught a pass. GS took down The Citadel 34-0 as they were +261 yds and +18 FD's. GS returns 9 s'trs on offense from a unit that avg'd 466 ypg last season and they add veteran QB Davis Brin to run HC Helton's system. UAB comes in ranked #127 in experience as they return a total of 7 s'trs and have a brand new HC in Trent Dillfer who ahs never coached at this level. GS is 3-0 ATS as a home favorite under HC Helton and UAB did go 0-6 ATS last season on the road. We think the Eagles high-powered offense will take over here and lead GS to a victory by DD's.

Louisiana by 10 over OLD DOMINION - First meeting. Despite returning just 7 s'trs TY ODU hung with VA Tech for 3Q last week before VT pulled away and won 36-17 (4★ PS and LP winner on VT). LA faced NWSU last week and won 38-13 (+242 yds) and this season the Cajuns do return just 9 s'trs and they are rated #108 in experience, however they did start QB Woodbridge who threw for 3 td's last week. ODU comes in to '23 rated as #130 in experience and ODU's offense put up just 295 yds and were -3 TO's vs VT and new QB Wilson was an effective runner (81 yds) but only threw for 94 yds as he was under contant pressure all gm. Last season ODU was just 1-5 ATS at home including 0-4 ATS in SBC games, however the Cajuns went just 1-3 ATS as an away favorite last season. Both teams are well-coached, but LA seems like the more talented team overall and we see them getting the win here by over a td.

North Texas by 10 over FIU - These teams met the last 2 seasons as part of CUSA and now enter this one as non-conf foes. NT won the last 2 meetings by a combined score of 101-21 and easily covered in both. The Mean Green were taken to the woodshed in the 2H of their 58-21 (+6) home loss to Cal in HC Eric Morris's UNT debut. UNT trailed 27-21 with 1:47 left in the 2Q, but allowed a TD with :07 left before half and never recovered as they allowed 25 unanswered points in the 2H. UNT rushed for just 41 (1.5) and their QB's (Earle & Rogers) combined to throw 3 ints. The Mean Green defense didn't put up much resistance up front as they allowed 357 rush yds (6.6). FIU escaped with a 14-12 (-10') win over FCS Maine, despite being outgained 378-305 and losing the first down battle 27-13. The Panthers were held to just 13 rush yds, but got 2 td passes by QB Keyone Jenkins, who hit 15-30 for 292. FIU HC Macintyre in 16-13 ATS as a home dog, including 3-2 last year and we think the Panthers can keep this one within a line that opened at almost 2 tds.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 8 over Jacksonville St - Only met once before & that was in '16 when both were FCS teams and JSU won a close game 27-26. JSU is off to a 2-0 start in year 1 as an FBS member after they beat East Tenn St 49-3 last week (3★ Small College LP winner!). Coastal is off a trip to UCLA where they trailed just 14-13 after 3Q but turned the ball over 2 times and were SOD in 4Q and lost 27-13. JSU's offense looks to be run-heavy so far TY as they avg 223 ypg (4.5) and have ran the ball 100 times in 2 gms while passing just 39. Coastal is #33 in experience led by QB McCall, but he threw 2 int's last week and CC does have a new HC in Tim Beck and the offense may take some time to learn as CC did not look the same last week. Coastal was just 1-5 ATS a season ago as a home favorite and JSU looks like a solid team that will give Coastal a tough game & we think this game stays within single digits.

Connecticut by 1 over GEORGIA ST - First meeting. The Panthers are off a 42-35 win but failed to cover as a 17' pt HF over a good FCS foe (Rhode Island). They actually trailed 28-21 3Q before scoring 21 straight. They were actually outgained 520-424 but benefitted by being +2 TO's. UConn is off a 24-14 loss to NC State but covered as a 14 pt HD as they only trailed 17-14 3Q and were only outgained 364.273. While GSU opened as the favorite UConn is actually the more experienced team (#12-#66) with 17 returning starters compared to just 12 for Georgia St. They also has a big edge on defense (#92-#132) as they return 12 of their top 15 tacklers. We think the Huskies are the better team so will take the points here.

Memphis by 14 over ARKANSAS ST - 61st meeting and these teams met each of the last 3 years and Memphis has won all 3, but Ark St is 3-0 ATS. LY the Tigers scored 2 tds in the final 2:08 to turn a 32-31 deficit into a 44-32 (-14.5) win as they outgained the Red Wolves 547-370. Memphis is off a season opening 56-14 (-48) win over FCS Bethune Cookman. The Tigers defense pitched a shutout as both BC tds were scored by the defense and BC was limited to just 91 total yds. Memphis put up 551 yds of offense led by QB Seth Henigan who threw for 334 and 2 tds (2 int). Arkansas St was destroyed 73-0 (+36') at Oklahoma as they were outgained 642 to 208 and were down 45-0 at the half. The Red Wolves allowed 220 rush yds (4.5) and didn't register a sack. Arkansas St is just 2-5 ATS as a home dog under Butch Jones, but they always seem to hang tough against the Tigers and we expect them to do it again.

Ucf by 3 over BOISE ST - Only prior meeting was back in 2021 in Florida and in that game Boise led 21-0 2Q and 24-14 at HT but allowed UCF to comeback and win 36-31 (-290 yds). Boise actually led Wash 6-0 1Q last week but were outscored 56-13 over the L/3 quarters while UCF played last Thur at home vs Kent St and put up 723 yds in a 56-6 win where QB Plumlee scored 4 total td's. This will be UCF's furthest trip out west since playing Stanford in 2015. After losing just 5 games at home between 2013-2019, Boise has lost 6 home games the last 3 seasons incl 5 under Avalos and overall Boise is on an 0-4 ATS run in home games against non-conf foes as they lost to Okla St 21-20 (-3) in '21 and to BYU 31-28 (-8) last ssn. This is only the 3rd time Boise will be a home dog since 2013 and the last time was in '20 when they lost 51-17 (+4) vs BYU. UCF comes into this season #9 in experience and QB Plumlee along with HC Malzahn have played in big road games before and we like UCF to win on the Blue Turf but we'll just sit back & watch as we are right at the line here.

RUTGERS by 14 over Temple - Rutgers has won 6 straight in the series, including wins each of the last 2 years. The Scarlet Knights won 16-14 (-18.0) last year, despite being outgained 264-201. The Knights are off a 24-7 (-6) win over Northwestern on Sunday. They outgained the Wildcats 285-201 as they limited Nwst to just 12 rush yds. Rutgers QB Gavin Wimsatt went 17-29 for 163 and a td. Temple actually trailed 21-10 at HT in last week's opener vs Akron despite being a 10 pt HF. The Owls rallied in the 2H as their defense held the Zips scoreless and QB EJ Warner threw 2 td passes to RB Edward Saydee and Temple escaped with a 24-21 win. Warner finished 28-49 and 292 yds as Temple got their 1st season opening win since 2019. Temple is 9-5 ATS vs Big10 foes s/'10, but Rutgers has big physical edges on both side of the ball, so we like the Scarlet Knights by 2 tds in this one.

MARYLAND by 21 over Charlotte - 2nd meeting. Maryland won 56-21 (-28) last year as they outgained the 49ers 617-388. The Terps are off a 38-6 (-38') win over FCS Towson as QB Taulia Tagavailoa threw for 260 and 3 tds in 3 quarters worth of work. The Maryland defense limited Towson to just 276 total yds, but did allow 148 (4.4) rush yards. Charlotte is also off a win over an FCS foe as they dispatched South Carolina St 24-3 (-28). The 49ers defense held SCSU to just 168 total yds, including only 59 pass yds. It took a quarter for the Charlotte offense to get going, but they scored 17 unanswered in the 2Q to lead 17-3 at the break. On paper, Charlotte is one of the most inexperienced team (#124 on EC), but they brought in over 40 transfers with a dozen of so from FBS schools and we think their defense can keep this one from getting too out of hand.

FLORIDA ST by 24 over Southern Miss - These two last met in the '17 Independence Bowl when FSU won 42-13 (-16'). FSU is on short rest after an impressive 45-24 (+11') win over LSU which cashed our Sunday Night Marquee. The 'Noles trailed 17-14 at half then scored the next 31 points. They have their ACC opener at BC on deck. SM won their opener 40-14 (-24) over FCS Alcorn St. Clemson transfer QB Billy Wiles got the start and threw for 267 yds and 3 td's. SM did go 3-1 as an away dog including a cover at Miami where they only trailed 10-7 at half, losing 30-7 as 26' pt dogs. The Golden Eagles also won at Tulane last year as 12' pt dogs. FSU has a big edge in depth and experience (#2 vs #51) but might be in for an emotional letdown after a physical game last week. We certainly don't doubt that FSU will win this game but with the line over four td's we have a lean on the underdog Golden Eagles.

USC by 38 over Stanford - The Cardinal are on the road for a 2nd straight wk following a 13 pt win against Hawaii where QB Ashton Daniels went 25-36-248-2-0 in his 1st career start. The Trojans on the other hand are already playing their 3rd contest at home with wins against MW foes San Jose St (501-396 yd edge in 28 pt win) and Nevada (668-360 yd edge in 52 pt win. QB Williams 18-24-319-5-0). In their meeting on "The Farm" a year ago, the Trojans (-9) led 35-14 at HT and 41-14 into the 4Q before allowing 2 TD to "only" win 41-28 (USC 505-441 yd edge). Stanford has had plenty of issues the past 2 years inside of the P12 with just a 3-15 ATS mark while their 4-11 ATS run as an AD is equally poor. With the Cardinal breaking in so many new starters on both sides of the ball in the first year of HC Troy Taylor and now entering conf play, laying the heavy points with the Trojans seems like the smart thing to do!

Auburn by 3 over CALIFORNIA - First meeting. The Hugh Freeze era got off to a strong start last week, beating UMass 59-17 (-35'). They had a 492-301 yd edge & 27-11 FD edge with 16, 35, 29 & 42 yd td drives and a pick-6 in the 3Q. Cal only led North Texas 27-21 and lost TCU transfer QB Sam Jackson late in the 1H. They scored a td with :09 left in the half then outscored NT 25-0 in the 2H to win 58-21 (-6'). The Golden Bears 58 pts and 669 yds was their most since 2015. Auburn has 9 starters back on D but they did give up 172 yds in the 1H last week vs UMass. Cal's backup QB Ben Finley has starting experience when he played at NCSt and threw for 279 yds last week. Wilcox is 10-4 as a home dog and Freeze is 13-16 for his career as a road favorite so we wouldn't be surprised if the Bears keep this closer than expected.

4★ BALTIMORE over Houston - The Ravens have won and covered 6 of their past 7 season openers with a 28 pt avg MOV in those wins. HOU meanwhile has gone just 4-9-1 ATS as a NDIV HD. BAL picked up victories in 10 of their 12 all-time meetings with HOU including a 33-16 (-7) road win in '20 where they finished with 23-18 FD and 407-304 yd edges. They have however gone just 3-10 ATS in recent contests as home chalk. Despite that poor mark, the Texans have plenty of new faces across the roster and coaching staff with rookie QB CJ Stroud getting his feet wet against one of the better defenses in the NFL (#3 in NFL LY all g just 18.5 ppg) and BAL HC Harbaugh is 14-2 SU when hosting rookie QB's!

FORECAST: BALTIMORE by 17

3★ WASHINGTON over Arizona - The Cardinals appear to be in rebuild mode as they enter the '23 season with rookie HC Jonathan Gannon taking over a roster influx that lost some big names in DeAndre Hopkins and JJ Watt. WASH meanwhile is also making some changes at key positions with 2nd year QB Sam Howell (169, 58%, 1-1 ratio LY) taking over. In their '20 meeting, the Cardinals (-7) jumped out to a 20-0 HT lead in their eventual 15 pt home victory (ARZ 438-316 yd edge). While Tyler Murray was under center in that matchup (353 tt yds, 3 TD), the same cannot be said here as a late season ACL in '22 has him on the PUP to start the year. While ARZ is an impressive 10-3 ATS as an AD, the vicious front 4 for the Commanders will be the game-changer in this one.

FORECAST: WASHINGTON by 14

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ PITTSBURGH by 6 over San Francisco - The home team in this series has won 5 straight (4-1 ATS, 17 pt avg MOV) including a 24-20 win by the 49ers in '19 where they finished with substantial FD (26-11) and yardage (436-239) edges (SF -3 TO's). After failing to cover each of their 5 matchups against the NFC in '21, the Steelers were much better a year ago with a 4-1 ATS mark. The 49ers on the other hand failed to cover 4 of 5 against the AFC. While the 49ers did cover 7 of their L/8 to end the '22 regular ssn, they are just 1-5 ATS as a NDIV AF. With the Steelers going 7-1-1 ATS when listed as a HD, we'll call for them to get the small outright upset as SF is playing at 10am PST in this one.

FORECAST: PITTSBURGH by 6

OTHER PLAYS

Detroit at KANSAS CITY - Thursday - The Chiefs are kicking off the NFL schedule for the 3rd time in 7 years as they welcome the upstart Lions who closed out last season covering 9 of their last 10 (8-2 SU). The Chiefs have picked up wins in each of the past 2 meetings with the Lions (1-1 ATS) including a 34-30 (-7) victory inside of Ford Field in '19. While KC has also covered 6 straight regular season matchups against the NFC and 5 of their L/6 contests in Wk 1, the Lions have gone 10-4 ATS as an AD and could stay within a TD here. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Carolina by 1 over ATLANTA - NFC South battle between a pair of teams that finished with identical 7-10 marks a season ago. The Panthers have plenty of new faces as they journey to ATL with Frank Reich taking over as HC and #1 overall pick Bryce Young starting at QB. The Falcons own an 8-3 SU (7-4 ATS) mark in recent matchups against the Panthers including a 37-34 OT home win a year ago. ATL however has gone just 2-8-1 ATS as a HF while failing to cover 6 of their past 7 ssn openers. With the Panthers going 8-3 ATS to close out LY and covering 5 of their 6 DIV contests, we'll give them a solid chance to pull off the road upset.

Cincinnati by 6 over CLEVELAND - Following a turbulent '22 ssn that saw their newly acquired franchise QB suspended for the first 11 games of the ssn, the Browns and Deshaun Watson enter TY with a clean slate and a talented roster on both sides of the ball. The Bengals meanwhile came up just short of a 2nd straight Super Bowl berth with KC getting a GW FG w/03 left to claim the AFC Championship. After being swept by the Browns in both '20 and '21, the Bengals were able to pick up a 23-10 (-4) LY inside of "The Jungle." With CIN also closing out LY's regular season on a perfect 8-0 ATS mark, we'll call for them to grab the victory here as they've also gone and impressive 8-3 ATS as an AF (QB Burrow expected to return from preseason inj here!).

Jacksonville by 7 over INDIANAPOLIS - A pair of AFC South foes heading in different directions face off here as the defending DIV Champ Jags head into Indy to take on a rebuilding Colts squad that opens up with a rookie HC and QB. This marks just the 4th time that the Colts have been a DIV HD dating back to the start of '13 (0-3 ATS in that role). The Jags meanwhile have been a DIV AF on just 5 occasions since 2011 with an impressive 4-1 ATS mark. While the home team in this series is on a perfect 11-0 SU run (7-2-2 ATS) with a 13 pt avg MOV in those matchups, the Colts' 1-7 ATS mark in ssn openers along with going just 3-10-1 ATS in recent DIV contests has use leaning in the visitor's direction.

MINNESOTA by 9 over Tampa Bay - Following another disappointing playoff performance where they suffered a home Wildcard loss to the Giants, the Vikings return to action having covered 7 of their past 8 home openers. The Bucs were also knocked out of the '22 playoffs early a ssn ago in what was future HOF QB Tom Brady's final game. The Bucs have come out victorious in 7 of the past 9 meetings (SU & ATS) including a 26-14 (-7) win in '20 (MIN 27-17 FD & 335-303 yd edges). They are however on just a 2-12-1 ATS run which doesn't bode well for newly added QB Baker Mayfield and company.

NEW ORLEANS by 6 over Tennessee - Following a 7-10 ssn a year ago where they were held to just 19.4 ppg, the Saints' offense appears to be heading in the right direction for '23 with Derek Carr taking over under center. While the Titans also had some offensive struggles LY averaging just 17.5 ppg, it appears that they'll at least begin the ssn with Ryan Tannehill at QB despite bringing in a pair of draft picks at the position in each of the past 2 years (#2DC Will Levis TY). In their most recent meeting in '21, the Saints (+3) dropped a 23-21 contest in Nashville (missed 2 pt conv w/1:16 remaining, NO 22-17 FD & 373-264 yd edges). While the Saints have also failed to cover 7 of their past 9 ssn openers (trailed ATL 16-7 at HT LY in the eventual 1 pt win!), the Titans were just 1-6 ATS to close out the '22 campaign.

CHICAGO by 6 over Green Bay - While the Jets were the biggest offseason winner with the trade for Aaron Rodgers, the Bears may have also benefited from the move as Rodgers "owned" his matchups with CHI going 25-5 all-time (GB on an 8-0 SU/ATS run with a 13 pt avg MOV). The Jordan Love era officially begins for the Packers and his previous action, although limited, has seen him struggle (0-1 as starter, 60%, 3-3 ratio). While GB is just getting started with their new starter, the Bears are excited about what they got out of Justin Fields a year ago in his 2nd year under center as his numbers shot up with 2,242 yds in the air and an additional 1,143 yds on the ground (25 tt TD). While CHI has gone just 2-11 ATS in contests inside of the NFC North, we expect them to handle business here as the Packers have failed to cover 8 of their past 12 road openers.

DENVER by 1 over Las Vegas - It was a pretty dismal year for the DEN fanbase LY as the acquisition of Russell Wilson had the Broncos in the preseason discussion for the playoffs. Obviously the marriage between Wilson and rookie HC Nathaniel Hackett was annulled before '22 finished

with DEN ranking DEAD LAST in ppg at just 16.9. Sean Payton returns to coaching following a year off and will look to turn the offense into what he had in the "Big Easy". The Raiders were also off of a disappointing year that saw Derek Carr let go following the season. Jimmy G takes over for the Silver & Black to lead a team that's been an impressive 11-5 ATS as an AD. The Broncos have actually dropped 6 straight (1-5 ATS) against their rival including a 22-16 OT defeat LY in "Mile High" where the Raiders had a 407-320 yd edge. With DEN also failing to cover 6 straight as home chalk, we'll call for this meeting to go right down to the very end.

Miami by 3 over LA CHARGERS - One of the better Wk 1 matchups takes place here between a pair of squads that earned playoff berths a year ago (both lost in WC Rnd). The Dolphins head West with a healthy Tua Tagovailoa under center to take on a Chargers team that has one of the better rosters on both sides of the ball. In MIA's trip to SoFi a year ago, the Chargers (+3) picked up a 23-17 upset victory with 24-14 FD and 432-219 yd edges (QB Herbert 39-51-367-1-0). While the Chargers are a solid 7-2-2 in Wk 1, they have gone just 4-13-1 ATS as NDIV home chalk. With MIA covering 7 of their 9 ssn openers, it wouldn't surprise us to see the visitor earn the outright upset.

Philadelphia by 6 over NEW ENGLAND - Rematch of the 2017 Super Bowl that saw the Eagles (+4) pick up a 41-33 upset thanks in part to the "Philly Special". The Patriots and Eagles did meet one time since the "Big Game" with NE (-4) going on the road to pick up a 17-10 win (PHI held to just 255 yds). After being an outstanding 7-1 ATS as a HD dating back to '06, the Patriots have surprisingly dropped each of the past 4 including an 0-3 ATS mark a season ago. While the Eagles have failed to cover 12 of their L/15 as a NDIV AF, they'll be out to prove that LY's amazing season wasn't just a fluke.

SEATTLE by 2 over LA Rams - Following a rough/injury-plagued '22 campaign that saw them go from Super Bowl Champs to just 5-12, the Rams head North to take on a Seahawks squad that delivered quite the surprise season a year ago with a 9-8 record and a WC berth with Geno Smith taking over for the departed Russell Wilson. After winning 3 consecutive matchups against the Seahawks including a 30-20 WC victory in SEA, the Rams dropped both contests a year ago (19-16 OT loss in LY's ssn finale). With revenge on their mind in this one along with a 5-1 ATS run in ssn openers, we'll go ahead and call for the Rams to stay within a FG in this one as SEA has failed to cover 7 of their L/10 as a HF.

Dallas at NY GIANTS - SNF - This marks the 7th time in the L/12 years that these NFC East rivals square off in the ssn opener with DAL winning 5 of the 1st 6 (4-1-1 ATS). 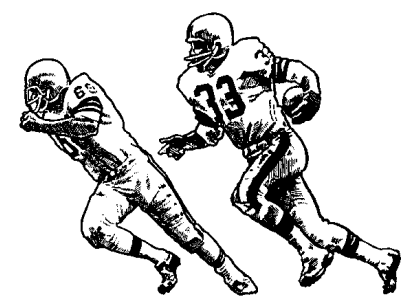
