COLLEGE SELECTIONS TEAM IN CAPS

KEY SELECTIONS

4★ COLORADO ST over Middle Tennessee - First meeting. This is the furthest west MT has traveled for a game since 2013. Colorado St is off a trip to the Big House where they lost 51-7 and only put up 219 yds, but it was vs a talented Michigan defense. MT is also off a bad loss, but that was against the newest FBS team James Madison where MT was -423 yds and lost 44-7. MT was outgained 301-24 yards and had a 19-2 first down deficit at halftime! The Blue Raiders allowed 287 pass yds & 6 td's last week and now faces a CSU offense that is at home & will be running the 'Air Raid' offense. Dating back to 2019 MT is just 5-8 ATS against non-conf foes and now they travel to the elevation against a Rams team that we think is much better than they showed last week. We see CSU's offense having a big day & the Rams getting the win by DD's for our top play.

FORECAST: COLORADO ST by 16 3★ CENTRAL MICHIGAN over South Alabama - First meeting. South Alabama last faced a MAC foe last year when they hung on to beat BG (-14) 22-19 with a GW FG on the final play. CMich is off a 58-44 loss to Oklahoma St, where they actually had the yards edge (546-531) as QB Richardson threw for 424 yds & 4 td's! SAla returns 16 starters under 2nd year HC Wommack including 8 starters from a DEF that held foes to 355 ypg LY. The Jaguars did lose QB Bentley but add Toledo transfer Bradley and the offense lost WR Tolbert to the NFL. SAla did win easily last wk vs an overmatched FCS Nicholls 48-7 (+343 yds). Jim McElwain has done a great job with Central Michigan and he is 11-2 ATS at home! CMich are also 8-3 ATS off a loss and we like the home Chippewas to get the win here as SAla was 0-6 ATS on the road last season. We think that streak will continue here & CMich's offense was impressive last week despite the loss. FORECAST: CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 14 3★ ILLINOIS over Virginia - Last year was the only regular season meeting ever between these two and UVA won 42-14 (-10'). UVA won last week in Tony Elliott's debut, 34-17 (-21) over FCS Richmond. The Cavaliers put up 505 yards but will face a much stiffer test against Illinois who has allowed 287 ypg in their first 2. The Illini had some bad luck in last week's loss to Indiana where they held a 448-362 yard edge but gave up the game winning td with just :23 left. The Cavaliers have 0 starters back on the OLine and face an Illini Dline that just held Indiana to 32 rush yards. RB Chase Brown had 151 rush vs WY and 199 vs Indiana. He should have a big game against UVA's D that allowed 226 rush (5.8) last year and 170 (4.9) last week vs the Spiders. There is some value here with the Illini who are angry off a loss and they've got the edge in the trenches here so we are calling for a nearly 2 touchdown victory. FORECAST: ILLINOIS by 13

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ KANSAS ST over Missouri - These former Big 12 foes have met 97 times, but have not met since 2011. Mizzou is off a 28 pt win vs LTech but are facing a much tougher test here. The Tigers lost their workhorse RB Badie & have a new QB in Cook. KSt has 7 starters back on offense led by star RB Vaughn & they added veteran QB Martinez. The KSt offense LW ran for 297 yds & 4 diff players scored a td. KSt also has 7 starters back from a DEF that held foes to 52 ypg under their season average last year led by stud DE Anudike-Uzomah. Under Drinkwitz Mizzou is just 2-4 ATS as an AD and 6 of their 8 road losses under Drinkwitz are by DD's. We'll take the Wildcats here by 2 td's as they have a huge DEF edge (#12 vs #102). Kansas St HC Klieman is 7-3 ATS against non-conference foes while the Tigers were just 1-4 ATS on the road overall last season and come into this game #100 in experience this season.

FORECAST: KANSAS ST by 15

2★ Uab over LIBERTY - UAB is out for revenge after losing to Liberty last year in the debut of Protective Stadium. The game last year was tied 3-3 at half but the Blazers couldn't contain Malik Willis and lost 36-12. Willis is gone for Liberty but they did add Tenn transfer Kaidon Salter entered after QB Brewer was injured and backup QB Bennett was ineffective. Salter threw for 148 and ran for 65, leading Liberty to a 29-27 (-3') 3OT win over Southern Miss who lost their starting QB to injury. The Blazers are off an easy 59-0 win over Alabama A&M. This is Salter's first start and the Blazers were 5-1 ATS on the road last year. UAB has the experience edge (#25 vs #84) and a huge edge on defense (#25 vs #84). We went against Liberty for our Underdog POW last week and we are going against them again here, calling for the Blazers to win by double-digits.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 9TH

Louisville at UCF - UCF is out for revenge after last year's loss when QB Gabriel threw a 66 yard Pick-6 with :13 left to lose 42-35. UCF has 17 starters back and got off to a strong start, winning 56-10 (-43') over FCS SCar St last week. Ole Miss transfer John Rhys Plumlee threw for 308 and 4 td's along with 86 rush yds in his debut. UL was a major disappointment for us last week in their 31-7 loss at Syracuse. The Cards were outgained 449-334 but they did have chances to make it closer, getting intercepted in the end zone and were SOD on the SU2. The JMA Wireless Dome (formerly the Carrier Dome) was loud last week and a trip to The Bounce House will be no easier. UL is 3-6-1 as an AD while UCF is only 3-7 as a HF. Call 1-800-654-3448 to get our Thursday Night Marquee for \$12.

Boise St at NEW MEXICO - As MW foes Boise is 9-1 SU vs NMex (covered 4 of the Last 5 gms) & have won the L/3 meetings by over 33 ppg. Boise also has a big edge on ST's (#4 vs #123) and experience (#11 vs #121). Boise is off a game at Oregon St where they lost 34-17 and QB Bachmeier was benched while NMex hosted FCS foe Maine and won 41-0 and had a 242-49 yd edge and 19-0 FD edge at HT. NMex does have 12 st'rs back including 7 from a DEF that held foes to 14 ypg under their season average LY. NMex looks to be going back to more of an option-based attack & they add former KU QB Kendrick who will start. While there is no question Boise is the better team here, the line is near 3 td's and NMex has a better DEF than people realize. SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10TH

OHIO ST by 51 or Arkansas St - 1st mtg. Ark St is coming off a 58-3 win over FCS foe Grambling, outgaining the Tigers 572-102 w/a 33-9 FD edge. Ark St has lost their L/3 vs Top 10 tms by an avg of 51 ppg. The Red Wolves had one of the worst defenses in the country last year, allowing 506 ypg and they were dead last, allowing foes to put up 140 ypg above their average. OSU is off a hard fought 21-10 win (-16) over #5 ND. The Buckeyes trailed 10-7 at half, but scored 14 unanswered in 2H to secure the win. Their revamped D under new DC Knowles held the Irish to 253 ttl yds. Ohio St did lose leading WR Smith-Njigba early 1Q & he is likely out here. The Buckeys are off a huge win, but the talent & experience gaps are simply too large for this to be a competive gm. OSU has another non-Power 5 foe on deck (Toldeo), so no reason to look ahead & they should score early & often against an inexperienced Wolves squad.

North Carolina by 3 over GEORGIA ST - 2nd mtg. First was LY where UNC led by just 14 pts at HT, but poured it on in 2H and won 59-17. UNC is back on the road vs a Sun Belt team after facing App St last week and held on to win an offensive battle 63-61 after leading 41-21 in the 4Q. GSt is facing their 2nd straight P5 team after facing S.Car last week where they actually had the yds edge (311-306) and were only down 20-14 3Q but S.Car's L/2 td's were off of blk'd punts. This is the first time GSt is hosting a P5 team & will be fired up for this matchup. GSt is one of the most exp'd teams in the FBS TY (#3) while UNC is #67 and they already dealing with some inj issues. UNC gave up

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288 rush yds (6.7) LW to App St and now face a GSt team that avg'd 227 ypg (5.0) LY and they return their top 2 RB's & ran for 200 yds (5.0) vs S.Car. The Tar Heels are just 1-5 as an AF the last 2 years and we see a motivated GSt team giving UNC all they can handle.

PÉNN ST by 20 over Ohio - Ohio is just 1-5 in the series, but did pull a 24-14 upset (+6') last time in Happy Valley in 2012. The Bocats are coming off a 41-38 (+4') home win over FAU. Ohio QB Rourke threw for 345 yds & 4 TD's in the upset win. 2nd yr HC Albin was 0-4 ATS vs non-con tms in his 1st ssn leading the Bobcats. Penn St is off a 35-31 (-3') B10 road win over Purdue. 6th yr QB Clifford led a game winning TD drive with under 2 mins left & finshed with 282 yds & 2 TDs. The Bobcats are 12-5 as away dogs and they've been feisty in Happy Valley before & are coming off a confidence buildling win, so we like them to keep it within the number here.

Utsa by 3 over ARMY - These two last met in '20 when UTSA finished with a 383-358 yard edge

Utsa by 3 over ARMY - These two last met in '20 when UTSA finished with a 383-358 yard edge but Army won 28-16 which gave us a 3★ LP Totals winner on the Under (49). UTSA was 5-1 SU/ATS on the road last year with the only loss coming in their road finale vs North Texas when they had the CUSA Title game on deck and pulled QB Harris in the 2Q. Harris threw for 337 and rushed for 63 yards last week but UTSA lost in the 3rd OT on a 2 pt conversion 37-35 (+4). The Roadrunners led 21-7 3Q and finished with 441-346 yd & 24-20 FD edges. Army had a role reversal last week as Coastal Carolina used ball control (36:16-23:44 TOP) and the ground game (53-263 rush) to beat Army 38-28. The Black Knights had 57% their yards come on 3 plays (70 yd run, 54 yd pass, 73 yd pass) that resulted in td's and CC held a 30-11 FD edge. UTSA only allowed 140 (3.2) rush last week. We will take the Roadrunners to be the one to bounce back off a loss and win a close game MIAMI, FL by 29 over Southern Miss- First meeting. Miami has covered just 1 of their last 8 as home chalk vs FBS foes and while that was under Diaz, Cristobal is only 13-22-2 as a home favorite in his career. We won our Underdog POW on these pages last week when the Bulldogs nearly upset Liberty as 3' pt dogs, losing 29-27 in OT despite QB Keyes getting hurt. The 'Canes blew out Bethune-Cookman 70-13 (-49') last week. SMiss failed to cover their first 9 games under Will Hall but they've now covered their last 4 games. If Keyes is out the Golden Eagles will likely turn back to running the Wildcat with RB Frank Gore Jr whose dad was a star here. SMiss is only 2-7 ATS vs non-conference teams and the Wildcat worked well against CUSA schools and Liberty but Miami's D is loaded with talent and added transfers. Miami has a huge game vs A&M on deck so we are cutting our lean off just over 4 td's.

NORŤHWESTERŃ by 10 over Duke - 6th mtg in the L/8 yrs. Duke has won the L/3 in the series, incl a 30-23 (+2') home win LY. They also won & covered last time in Evanston back in '18, w/a 21-7 (+2') upset win. Duke is off a 30-0 (-7) home win over Temple in new HC Elko's debut. The Blue Devils held the Owls to just 179 ttl yds. Duke QB Leonard threw for 328 yds (24-30) & 2 TDs & was also the leading rusher (64 yds, 5.8). Duke is now 30-9 ATS in non-conf gms since '13. N'Western is off a bye, after a scoring a Week 0 victory over Neb in Dublin. NW showed an improved OFF in the opener, putting up 528 yds, incl 314 yds thru the air from QB Hlinski who hit 71% with 2 TDs w/o a TO. The Wildcats are 4-9-2 ATS vs non-conf s/17 & are 4-8-1 ATS as a HF since '18, so the angles seem to point towards Duke, but we have no real lean here after Northwestern's offensive showing in their opening win.

ARKANSAS by 11 over South Carolina - These two last met in '17 in Columbia when SC scored 3 defensive td's in a 48-22 win. Ark has lost their last 6 SEC home openers but were only favored in one of those. Spencer Rattler threw 2 int's against Georgia St last week. The Gamecocks only led 20-14 3Q then got two blocked punt td's for a misleading 35-14 (-12') final. Ark led Cincy 14-0 at half. Their D struggled in the 2H but they held on to win 31-24 (-6'). The Hogs allowed 325 pass so we expect Rattler to have a better game. The Gamecocks pass D was impressive last week, holding GASt's QB to 7 of 29 for 111 yards. SC has a decent experience edge here (#43 vs #83) but Arkansas clearly looked like the better team and they are at home so we lean with the Hogs.

Alabama by 17 over TEXAS - Two power house programs meet in the regular season for the first time in 100 years. This is Bama's first non-conference road game since 2011 when they beat Penn St in State College 27-11. Nick Saban's first National Title came in the last meeting when the Tide beat the Longhorns 37-21 (-4) in the BCS Championship game. Former Bama OC Steve Sarkisian has 14 starters back from a 5-7 squad. This is the first test for Ohio St transfer QB Quinn Ewers who threw for 225 yards in UT's 52-10 (-37') win over ULM last week. Ewers will have to deal with a Bama D that has 7 starters back including Nagurski Award winner Will Anderson. Bama is off a dominant 55-0 (-41') win over Utah St. Texas' secondary should be improved and the crowd noise should help slow down Bama's potent offense led by Heisman winner Bryce Robinson. Last year Bama had close games into the 4th quarter against Florida, Tenn, LSU, Ark and Aub and also lost to A&M. They should win this game but we think Texas hangs around into the 4Q and loses by just over 2 td's.

Wake Forest by 11 over VANDERBILT - Vandy won 3 straight meetings from '11.'13 under James Franklin. The 'Dores had a blowout win over Hawaii, which gave us our first 2★ Power Sweep and 3★ LP Winner this season, but last week gave up 31 points to FCS Elon and only won 42-31 (-19')! QB Wright had 163 rush against the 'Bows. WF beat up on FCS VMI last week with Mitch Griffis making his first career start and throwing for 288 yds and 3 td's in place of injured Sam Hartman. Vandy is looking to end an 11 game home losing streak vs FBS foes. Clark Lea is building momentum with this squad and they only need 1 more win to surpass the public's expectations (O/U 2.5 wins) but we love the job Dave Clawson has done at WF and seeing this line at just a touchdown was surprising. The 'Dores were outgained last week by Elon and we think Wake Forest will handle the road trip and win by double-digits.

Western Michigan by 4 over BALL ST - The Cardinals are 3-1 SU & 4-0 ATS vs the Broncos the last 4 years including 2 straight. Ball St has not won 3 straight in series since 2007-09. Last year Ball St won 45-20 as a 12' pt AD scoring the games last 28 points. The Visitor is 1-4 SU & 2-3 ATS. LTH WM led 27-13 into the 4Q but with the game tied at 27 allowed a GW FG with :29 left to lose 30-27 (E). Both teams are off opening road losses against P5 schools. Ball St was dominated by Tennessee trailing 38-0 at HT & 52-7 into the 4Q losing 59-10 as a 35' pt AD. While WM trailed Michigan ST 21-3 AT HT they scored 10 unanswered in 3Q & only trailed 21-13 before allowing 2 td in final 6:26 including a front door covering 1 pl/43 yd td "drive" with 4:07 left to lose 35-13 as a 21 pt AD. While WM's rFr QB Jack Salopek, did well in his first career start (21-36-193-0-0, 36 rush) he was sacked 7 times!!! That does not bode well he as Ball St returns 8 of their top 10 DL back & add a Mich St transfer. Ball St's JR QB John Paddock also did well (24-43-269-1-2) but the team kept his uniform clean (0 sk allowed). Both teams return 11 starters and while WM may have the talent edge overall the Cardinals have the edge at the LOS on both sides & we look for them to keep it under the almost td that it has opened at.

NOTRE DAME by 24 over Marshall - First mtg. Marshall is of an easy 55-3 (+412 yds) win vs FCS Norfolk St while ND is off a 21-10 loss against Ohio St where they led 10-7 at HT. Marshall is under 2nd year HC Huff who guided MU to 7-6 and a bowl LY. The Herd return 11 starters but are without star RB Ali (1401, 5.6, 23 td LY), who is away from the team and they added QB Colombi from Tex Tech. MU does return 7 of the top 10 tkl'rs on defense incl their top 2. ND is under new HC Freeman but the Irish faired well last week in a tough environment & the moment didn't look too big fot rFr QB Buchner. Dating back to 2017 ND is 5-2 ATS off a SU loss and have covered 8 straight regular season games dating back to last season. We think ND takes this game by over 3 td's as Marshall is without their best offensive player and are going into a hostile environment against an angry ND team looking for their first win under HC Freeman & only has Cal on deck. The Irish have been kind to us during their ATS run including last year's College GOY (28-3 over UVA) so we will keep riding with the Irish.

Maryland by 31 over CHARLOTTE - First meeting. The shine is off Will Healy after an 0-2 start with a 30 point loss to FAU and a 17 point loss to FCS William & Mary. The 49ers were without QB Chris Reynolds then lost backup QB James Foster to a hand injury. Maryland was lethargic in last week's 31-10 (-24) win over Buffalo. QB Tagovailoa threw 0 td's for the first time since his debut in '20. The Terps did lead 17-0 and scored on the 2nd play of the 3Q to make it 31-7. Charlotte is -192 ypg already. They've allowed 261 rush (5.4) and MD's RB Roman Hemby had an impressive 70 yard td run last week. The Terps are just 4-10 ATS on the road and Charlotte did upset Duke last year at home, but they've also failed to cover their last 5 with their last 7 losses coming by 23 ppg. We think Taulia has a better performance and the 49ers may be playing with their 3rd string QB. The Terps win by over 4 td's.

PITTSBURGH by 3 over Tennessee - The Johnny Majors Classic returns for a 2nd straight season. Last year Pitt built a 41-27 4Q lead and won by a touchdown. Both teams enter with extra rest. The Panthers need it after a hard fought 38-31 win in the renewal of the Backyard Brawl. Pitt had to overcome a blocked punt in the 2Q but got a 58 yard Pick 6 by MJ Devonshire with just 2:58 left then a SOD at the Pitt28 to secure the win. Tenn was much more comfortable last week, building a 38-0 lead over Ball St and won 59-10 (-34'). Pitt has one of the top Dline's in the country, which produced 54 sacks last year. The Vols Oline allowed 44 sacks last year including 5 against this defense. Kedon Slovis was solid in his debut, throwing for 308 yards and a td. Narduzzi felt ESPN disrepected Pitt's fans after the game by saying WV would fill 75% of the crowd but the stadium was clearly full of Pitt fans and we expect another close win thanks to a home field edge.

Memphis by 3 over NAVY - MEM leads the all-time series 4-3, but Navy is 5-2 ÅTS. The HT has won 5 of the 7 mtgs, but MEM won 10-7 (-13') the last time here in '20. Navy is coming off B2B losing ssns for the 1st time under HC Niumatalolo & lost their ssn opener 14-7 to FCS Delaware. The Middies outgained the Blue Hens 329-202, but lost 3 fumbles & were held to just 3.1 ypc on the ground. Memphis (+16') lost 49-23 at Miss St last wk, which moves their road record to 2-8 SU & 0-9 ATS on the road under HC Silverfield. The Tigers trailed 28-3 at HT & allowed 450 pass yds to Miss St HC Leach's "Air Raid" OFF & now face the run-heavy offense of Navy. The Middies are on 35-20-1 ATS vs AAC foes. We expect MEM to pull out a close win on the road, but based on recent history we simply don't trust them to cover on the road.

AIR FORCE by 20 over Colorado - Have met 17 times, but just once since 1974. The most recent mtg came back in '19 when AF traveled to CU and won outright 30-23 in OT as a 3'-pt underdog. AF won 48-17 vs FCS Northern lowa where they ran for 582 yds (9.4) while CU played last Fri at home & trailed just 7-6 HT vs TCU but fell behind 2H and lost 38-13. CU's rush defense was gashed last week for 275 (9.2) and they now face an AF option attack that returns 5 of their top 6 rushers led by leading rusher from LY TB Roberts (1356, 4.5, 13 td LY) and QB Daniels (734 rush, 4.7, 11 td LY) and they both topped 100 rush yds last wk. AF also returns an exp'd OLine with 4 st'rs. The AF DEF held foes to 79 ypg under their ssn avg LY (#7 FBS) and return 7 st'rs from that DEF. S/'16 AF is 18-6 ATS against non-conf foes & are 9-5 ATS as a HF since 2019. We see the Falcons gashing CU on the ground, playing stout DEF and getting the win by nearly 3 td's.

TEXAS A&M by 24 over Appalachian St - First mtg. This is the first time App St will be a DD dog since the '18 opener at Penn St. A&M had no trouble vs Sam Houston winning 31-0 (+299 yds) while App St lost 63-61 despite scoring 40 pts in the 4Q vs UNC last week (missed two 2-pt conv on L/2 td's). A usually reliable App St DEF was gashed last week for 567 yds now faces a Texas A&M offense led by QB King, RB Achane, and WR Smith. App St QB Brice threw for 361 yds & 6 td's last week but now faces a MUCH better pass defense that finished #7 last season and returns all 4 starters. Texas A&M is 14-8 ATS as a HF and 12-4 ATS vs non-conf foes under HC Fisher, and while A&M does have a bigger game on deck against Miami,FL next week at home we seem them winning by 3 td's as App St's defense is a concern & their offense faces a much better DEF in a hostile road environment

WISCONSIN by 24 over Washington St - 1st mtg since '07. WISC is 2-0 SU/ATS in the series. WSU opened with a 24-17 over FCS Idaho, despite going down 10-0 in 1Q. Cougs QB Ward (transfer from FCS Incarnate Word) threw for 215 yds (3-0 ratio) in his FBS debut. Wash St is 1-4 SU/ATS vs Big10 since '02 & just 5-10-1 ATS vs non-conf opponents s/'17. WISC dominated FCS Illinois St, as they outgained the Redbirds 440-243, with 221 yds on the ground. All-American candidate RB Allen ran for 148, incl a 96yd TD burst in 2Q. The Badgers are 16-10 ATS vs non-conf under HC Chryst & have another non-conf foe on deck (New Mexico St), so no reason to overlook the Cougars here. Wash St has struggled recently vs non-conf opponents, so we'll side with WISC in this one. MICHIGAN ST by 31 over Akron - Tms have not met since 1914. MSU is now 44-6 SU all-time vs

MICHIGAN ST by 31 over Akron - Ims have not met since 1914. MSU is now 44-6 SU all-time vs MAC, incl 7-0 s/115, after their 35-13 (-21) win over Western Michigan. The Spartans had a 21-3 HT lead, but allowed the Broncos to close within 1 score heading to the 4Q. MSU then scored 2 TDs within 2 1/2 mins to get the late cover, which moves them to 5-0 ATS vs non-conf tms under HC

Tucker. Akron escaped with a 30-23 OT win over FCS foe St. Francis (PA) in HC Joe Moorhead's debut with the Zips. Akron was actually outgained 436-374 & all'd 189 (4.7 ypc) on the ground. Moorhead was 0-4 as an AD while HC at Miss ST & Akron is 1-7 ATS vs non-conf L3Y. Mich St travels to Washington for a non-conf showdown next week, so might be looking ahead a bit. The Spartans should cruise to an easy win, but we aren't confident that they cover the almost 5 TD opening line.

CALIFÖRNIA by 10 over UnIv - First mtg. UNLV is just 6-32 SU vs Pac-12 foes and have lost 11 straight with their last win vs a Pac-12 tm coming in '08. UNLV played in Week 0 so are off a bye here while Cal beat UC Davis 34-13 as transfer QB Plummer threw for 268 yds & RB Ott ran for 104 yds. UNLV returns 12 strs & this looks to be their best team under HC Arroyo. The Rebels, who have struggled with FCS foes in the past, won their opener 52-21 vs Idaho St and starting QB Brumfield was 21/25 for 356 & 4 td's. Under HC Wilcox Cal doesn't have a great history as home chalk, going 4-11 ATS and 2 of those ATS wins were against FCS foes. Cal also has a trip to Notre Dame on deck and could be looking ahead. While we see Cal getting the win, this UNLV team has some talent and they went 4-2 ATS as an underdog on the road last season.

TEXAS TECH by 6 over Houston - In-state foes have met 33 times and TT has won 9 of the L/10 games SU and have gone 8-2 ATS in those mtgs. These tms met LY and TT trailed 21-7 HT but shutout Hou in the 2H and won 38-21. Hou hung on to win in 3 OT 37-35 LW and QB Tune threw for 3 td's and also was the #1 rusher. TT is under new HC McGuire and they return 12 st'rs (6 OFF/6 DEF). McGuire named QB Shough the starter but he was inj'd in the 1Q LW and is likely out here, but bkp QB Smith is talented & overall TT comb'd for 472 pass yds and now face a Hou pass D that gave up 337 yards last week vs UTSA. This looks like a fairly even game on paper, but TT has the home edge and we think their offense will make a couple key plays late and be the difference. IOWA by 4 over Iowa St - These in-state foes battle for the Cy-Hawk trophy. Iowa leads all-time series 46-22 SU and more recently have won the L/6 mtgs SU and are 4-1-1 ATS. Iowa is off a rough 7-3 win where their DEF outscored their offense (2 safeties, 1 fg) and they only gained 166 yds against South Dakota St. ISU also faced an FCS team last week & they won 42-10 (+149 yds). ISU comes into '22 as one of the least exp'd teams in the FBS (#130) as they return just 8 st'rs and lost their all-time leading passer & their #2 all-time leading rusher, but they do return AA DE McDonald & All-B12 WR Hutchinson along with 3 OL st'rs. Iowa enters TY #59 in experience as they return 7 st'rs on both sides of the ball. While we see lowa getting the win, we think this will be a close game & points could be at a premium as 8 of the L/9 mtgs have gone 'Under' the total with an avg of just 36 pts scored in those 8 'Under' games.

EAST CAROLINA by 17 over Old Dominion - This will be the 10th mtg, but just the 4th since 2013. The L/2 mtgs (2018, 2019) have been close wins by ECU by a comb'd 5 points. ECU cashed in a 3★ Power Sweep winner for us last week when they nearly upset NCSt as a 12'-pt dog as their kicker missed a PAT and FG in the 4Q & they were +39 yds vs NCSt and one of the td's they allowed was punt return td. ODU is off a 20-17 home upset of VTech, but they were helped out by 4 int's by VT and a botched FG snap that they ret'd for a td. ODU for the game was -95 yds as they only gained 245 yds on offense. ECU covered twice as double-digit chalk last year. These are 2 of the more exp'd teams coming into the season, but we like ECU to win here by 2 td's as ODU is off an emotional win & a misleading final score against an in-state foe and ECU nearly upset one of the better teams in the ACC and held QB Leary to 51% and 211 pass yds.

WEST VIRGINIA by 10 over Kansas - While WVU is 9-1 SU vs KU as B12 foes they have only covered 4 of those games and have failed to cover 4 of the L/6 matchups. LY KU (+15') hung with WVU the entire game and only lost 34-28. After 8 straight DD losses in 2021, KU upset Texas then lost 2 close games to B12 foes and now return a very exp'd team (#21). After struggling vs FCS foes in the past, KU ran over Tenn Tech 56-10 (+312 yds) with 297 rush yds (9.9 ypc). WVU opened with their bitter rival Pitt last week & nearly pulled the upset, but a late pick-six cost them. WVU's offense looked impressive at times last week with QB Daniels leading the way, but there could be some hangover after losing a rivarly game and now facing Kansas. We see some value on the Jayhawks and think KU can keep this game interesting.

FLORIDA by 10 over Kentucky - Florida is out for revenge after losing in Lexington for the first time since 1986. The 'Cats were outgained 382-224 in that game last year but won 20-13 thanks to a blocked fg returned for td. The Gators had a 31 game win streak in this series but they've now lost 2 of the last 4. Last week Florida upset #7 Utah in The Swamp 29-26, scoring the go ahead td with 1:25 left then sealing it with an int in the end zone. QB Richardson lived up his billing last week with 168 passing and 106 rushing and 3 td's vs a talented Utes D. KY only led 13-10 at half vs Miami then returned the KO 100 yards to start the 2nd half and went on to win 37-13 (-15). The 'Cats only held 353-290 yd & 20-17 FD edges. KY RB Rodriguez was #2 in the SEC in rushing last year but he remains suspended. The Gators have won their last 8 home games vs SEC East foes. We think the Gators get back to dominating this series and win HC Napier's SEC debut by more than a touchdown in The Swamp.

TOLEDO by 33 over Massachusetts -Former MAC foes, Rockets have won 5 straight over the Minutemen including a 45-7 win as a 27 pt AF LY. Toledo had a 460-134 yd & 22-8 FD edges in that game & led 31-0 at HT & 45-0 in 4Q. LTH('14) in MAC play UMass (+17) led 13-0 at one point but allowed a GW td with :34 left. That however was 8 ys ago & UMass has just 2 wins s/'19 and while they return 16 starters, they have a new HC and are trying rebuild from the basement up. LW UMass was a 28' pt AD against a Tulane team that was 2-10 in '21. While they only trailed 21-10 at HT, they allowed 21 unanswered in the 3Q before a scoreless 4Q to lose 42-10. While they did put up 200 yds rushing, their two QB's combined to hit just 4-11-17 with an 0-3 ratio. Toledo cruised to a 37-0 win over Long Island, they failed to cover as a 47 pt HF & led just 20-0 into 4Q. Toledo does have Ohio St on deck but we just can't lean with UMass until they reach ground level.

UL beat Texas St 45-0 LY as a 21 pt HF. Louisiana is 3-0 SU & 2-91 ATS vs MAC foes since '19 incl a 49-14 win over Ohio as a 20 pt HF LY. EM lost to Ohio 34-26 as a 6 pt HF LY. The Cajuns have the FBS's longest winning streak at 14 game including a 24-7 win LW as a 13 pt HF vs FCS Southeastern Louisiana but scored the covering td with just 1:37 left after a 39 yd td "drive". LW EM beat FCS EKU 42-34 but failed to cover as a 11 pt 111. Vision 2005 as an AD s'16 so we will take the DD points & the Eagles.

FORECAST: LOUISIANA by 4 beat FCS EKU 42-34 but failed to cover as a 11 pt HF. While Louisiana has the talent to win big EM

Syracuse by 27 over CONNECTICUT - Huskies lead series 6-5 SU & ATS & the HT is an even better 8-3 SU & ATS. Last mey in '18 when UConn (+28) only trailed 24-14 2Q & 41-21 in 4Q before allowing the final 10 & the front door cover. UConn beat their FCS foe LW but led just 14-3 into 4Q as a 20' pt HF getting the covering td with :36 left to win 28-3. Syracuse on the other hand had a shocking outright 31-7 upset of Louisville as a 4' pt HD. This is Huskies 3rd gm as the opened with a 31-20 loss at Utah ST as a 26 pt AD in new HC Jim Mora's first gm. Unfortunately in that gm they lost Penn St transfer QB Robinson likely for season and backup QB Turner hit just 12-31-109-1-2 in relief. While Turner improved LW (14-22-172-2-1) that was against Central Conn St. Syracuse held Louisville to 197 pass with an 0-2 ratio & we look for the Orange that came up 1 win from bowl eligibility LY to be focused here (LY beat Albany 62-24 as a 22 pt HF).

OKLAHOMA by 35 over Kent St - This is OU's 4th meeting vs a current MAC foe & 1st against Kent St. Last game vs a MAC team was in '15 when OU won 41-3 vs Akron. OU got the Brent Venables era off win a 45-13 win against UTEP where we cashed in a 3★ Late Phone Winner on the Over 57. Kent St is on the road for a 2nd straight week against a Power 5 foe and they lost last week at Washington by 25 pts. Oklahoma's offense looked productive with 259 rush yds & 233 pass yds and their defense got after the QB with 6 sacks last week. OU has a bigger game on deck next week at Nebraska but Kent St has failed to cover their L/7 games as an away dog

TULSA by 6 over Northern Illinois - First mtg. This is NIU's first regular ssn non-conf road game vs a non-P5 tm since a 34-28 loss at #19 San Diego St as a 10 pt AD in '17. Tulsa is 4-2 SU & ATS vs MAC foes s/'09 but last was a 54-51 loss at Toledo (+8) in '17. LW returning MAC Champions NIU led Eastern Illinois 28-6 late 3Q as a 35 pt HF but needed to hold on for a 34-27 win as they were outgained 441-379. Tulsa opened the season poorly as on just their 2nd play gave up a sack fumble that WY recovered for a td. Tulsa still led 34-24 early 4Q as a 6' pt AF but gave up a 55 yd FG & a 51 yd td pass in a less than 5 min span & lost in 2OT 40-37. While we look for Tulsa to bounce back NIU has a tendency to keep games close in the 4Q with their only losses by more than 7 LY were vs #25 Mich & vs WM in the game prior to MAC Championship, where they sat their starting QB.

TEXAS ST by 10 over Fiu - Not many people are likely tuning into this game. Last year Texas St (+2) won 23-17 in OT. The Bobcats were -4 TO's in last week's 38-14 loss to a depleted Nevada squad but yards were nearly even and they had a 15-13 FD edge. FIU trailed FCS Bryant 16-0 and rallied to win 38-37 (-10) in OT. QNB Grayson James did throw 4 td passes but FIU was outgained 470-377. This is HC MacIntyre's first road game at FIU and he was 23-18 as an AD in previous jobs at San Jose St and Colorado. TXSt is just 1-6-1 as a HF. It's hard to have faith in either squad so we are just putting this right at the line.

AUBURN by 28 over San Jose St - Aub has swept the two previous meetings 59-13 in '14 and 35-21 in '15. SJSt did not look good last week when they needed a late td to get by FCS Portland St. The Spartans were outgained 395-288, out FD'd 24-17 but were +3 TO's. Hawaii transfer QB Cordeiro completed just 50% of his passes. Now he deals with a hostile environment and an improved Auburn D. The Tigers are off a more convincing win over an FCS foe, beating Mercer 42-16 with a 497-271 yard edge. RB Bigsby returned and had 147 last week. The Tigers used both QB's TJ Finley and dual threat Robby Ashford. Auburn has covered 6 of their last 8 vs Non-Conference foes. They do have Penn St on deck but we still think the Tigers roll thanks to large edges on offense (#26 vs #128) and ST's (#5 vs #104).

NEBRASKA by 24 over Georgia Southern - 1st meeting. Georgia Southern is 0-12 SU vs Power 5 tms since joining FBS. Georgia Southern is coming off a 59-7 win over FCS foe Morgan St in Clay Helton's debut as head coach. QB Kyle Vantrease, a transfer from Buffalo, made his Eagles debut and threw for 346 yds (4-1 ratio), as GASO outgained Morgan St 500-250. Nebraska struggled at home vs FCS North Dakota & were actually tied late 3Q, before pulling away for a 38-17 win. The Huskers got the ground game going in 2H & RB Grant ended with 189 yds (8.2 ypc) & 2 TDs. Nebraska has Oklahoma looming next week, but tend to take care of lesser foes incl a 28-3 (-13') win vs Buffalo LY and a 44-8 (-14) win vs Northern Illinois in 2019. We'll give a small lean to the home team in this one considering Helton is 2-9 as an away dog in his career.

Usc by 12 over STANFORD - This is clearly revenge time for the visiting Trojans who dropped a shocking 42-28 (-17) home meeting in Wk 2 a year ago to the Cardinal costing HC Clay Helton his job. USC does have a commanding 63-34-3 all-time edge in this series although the past 10 have been split at 5 apiece. In their most recent trip to "The Farm" back in '18, they would cough up 3 TO's and be held to their fewest points since way back in 1941 (Stan 17-3 win as a 5 pt dog). Plenty of new faces for USC this time around including HC Riley and QB Williams (19-22-249-2-0, 68 rush) in LW's 42 pt home win over Rice (27-14 FD & 538-280 yd edges, 3 pick-6 TD's). The Cardinal meanwhile are in Palo Alto for a 2nd consec week (31 pt win LW over Colgate, 20-11 FD & 497-218 yd edges) and have an early bye on deck before B2B early ssn trips to Seattle and Eugene. Despite that rest edge coming up and confidence after picking up a win LY, the Cardinal have failed to cover 6 of their L/9 as a HD (USC 10-4 ATS run as an AF!).

OKLAHOMA ST by 10 over Arizona St - 4th mtg but haven't met since 1993. OSU QB Sanders began the season with 406 pass yds (4-0 ratio) and 2 rush td's vs CMich last Thur. While the OSU DLine returns a lot of talent, the back 7 of OSU's defense only has 1 returning starter & they allowed 424 pass vds to CMich. ASU opened with blowout 40-3 win over Northern Ariz last week where the DEF allowed just 120 yds & ASU ran for 267 (5.4). ASU does return just 7 st'rs and are one of the least exp'd teams in the country (#126) but they added QB Jones from Florida & RB Valladay. While OSU's offense looks to be clicking on all cylinders, their performance on defense has us worried a bit & HC Edwards is 7-2 ATS as a road underdog as the HC at Ariz St.

MICHIGAN by 52 over Hawaii - 4th meeting. Hawaii is 0-3 SU all-time vs Michigan & has been outscored 138-30 in the series. The Wolverines won the last meeting 63-3 (-38') in '16. 1st road game for the Rainbow Warriors under new HC Timmy Chang, who has one of the least experienced tms in FBS. HAW comes in 0-2 & has been outscored 112-27 on the season vs two much lesser foes, after a 49-17 (+16') loss to WKU. Michigan is off a 51-7 (-31) home win over Colorado St, as the Wolverines held the Rams to just 219 total yds. Michigan QB McNamara threw for a modest 136 yards & a score & HC Harbaugh previously announced JJ McCarthy will start here. The Wolverines were 5-1 ATS as HF LY, after struggling in that role in '21 (0-2 ATS). They can name the score in this one, it just depends on how long Harbaugh wants to keep his foot on the gas.

VIRGINIA TECH by 6 over Boston College - Both of these teams come in desperate off upset losses last week. QB Jurkovec returned against VT last year despite only having 50% of his grip strength. BC won 17-3 (+3) with a 346-222 yard edge. The Eagles are 8-3 ATS vs VTech since '11 but were crushed LTH 40-14 (+12'). The Hokies lost HC Pry's debut last week at ODU 20-17 (-6), largely thanks to QB Wells 4 int's and ODU had a fumble return td off a botched fg attempt by VT. VT did have a 340-245 yard edge while BC was actually outgained at home by Rutgers in their 22-21 (-8') loss. BC clearly strugged after losing all 5 OL starters, rushing for just 29 yards and they allowed 4 sacks. VT allowed just 80 rush yds (2.4) last week. The Hokies were the better team last week and should have won. With Pry's home debut and Enter Sandman getting the crowd fired up we think they bounce back and beat BC.

UTEP by 20 over New Mexico St - The I-10 Rivalry has been played every year since 1946 except '01, '03 & '20. The Miners are 9-3 SU/7-3-2 ATS in this rivalry since '09 but have lost 3 of the last 4. LY UTEP led 17-0 2Q & won 30-3 as the Miners D stopped NMSt in the redzone 4 times. UTEP enters 0-2 after getting beat by OK 45-13 (+31). New Mexico St has extra rest after getting beat by Minnesota 38-0 (+36) on Thursday Night. The Aggies were outgained 485-91 and allowed the Gophers to hold a 31-6 FD edge. The Miners are desperate for a good feeling after losing 7 of their last 8 dating back to last year. The offense should fair much better against a New Mexico St D that allowed 40 ppg last year and UTEP did only punt once in their season opening loss to North Texas then put up 316 yards last week vs Oklahoma. We think the Miners take out some frustration against an outmatched rival and win by nearly 3 td's.

Baylor by 1 over BYU - 4th meeting & their most recent matchup was last season in Waco where Baylor (-5) was up 17-7 HT and won 38-24 with the DEF getting 5 sks & holding BYU to 47 yds under their season avg. BYU is off a 50-21 blowout win at USF where they were +282 yds and put up 575 yds incl 314 rush yds (8.5 ypc). Baylor is off a 69-10 win vs Albany and they only have TXSt on deck so they won't be looking ahead while BYU has another tough gm on deck at Oregon. Baylor loses QB Bohanon, but HC Aranda likes QB Shapen & they have one of the top OLines in the nation. BU's DEF loses 5 st'rs incl the B12 DPOY, but they return one of the top DLines in the nation led by NT lka. BYU does have the big edge in experience (#5 vs #98), but we think BU has the better overall team speed, but they will have to battle with the altitude. With Baylor having the edge in the trenches on the OL and DL to go along with their speed, we think the Bears will be able to outlast a tough BYU team and pull the road upset.

FRESNO ST by 3 over Oregon St - First meeting since back in '03 when OSU allowed a FG w/:31 left to lose 16-14 as 8' pt away chalk. The Beavers are matching up against their 2nd straight MW foe here following a 17 pt win LW in Corvallis against Boise (led 24-0 at HT, 470-311 yd edge). The Bulldogs meanwhile are back in "The Valley" for a 2nd straight week after a Thursday night home win over Cal Poly where they had convincing FD (33-17) and yard (549-317) edges in a 28 pt win. Fresno St has actually done well in non-conference matchups over the past 5 years (13-5-1 ATS) that includes a 40-37 (+11) shootout win LY in the Rose Bowl against the Bruins and a 7 point loss as nearly 3 td dogs at Oregon. With the Beavers covering just 1 of 6 away from Reser Stadium a year ago, we have no issue giving the home team the edge here.

Mississippi St by 13 over ARIZONA - Following a week 1 home victory against Memphis where QB Rogers threw for 450 yds & 5 TD's (34-13 FD & 547-294 yd edges), former Washington St HC Leach heads back to his former conference for the 1st time in a late night matchup against the Wildcats (only 4th time MSU has taken on a P12 foe). Miss St has the stronger D here with 9 starters back. Arizona looked like a completely different team LW against the Aztecs with transfer QB de Laura throwing for 299 yds and 4 TD's in a 38-20 upset victory (UA 25-14 FD & 461-232 yd edges). While this is their 1st all-time meeting, the Wildcats have gone just 1-9-1 SU vs current SEC squads (lost to LSU 45-3 back in '06). That could eventually see the Bulldogs pull away late in this one with their deeper roster.

4★ TENNESSEE over Ny Giants - The Giants head into Nashville following their 5th consecutive season of double-digit losses. While the Titans earned the #1 seed in the AFC a year ago, they were unable to get out of the DIV Rnd with a surprising loss to the Bengals as a 4 pt favorite. These 2 last met in '18 with TEN (-1) picking up the 17-0 win (4th victory in 5 matchups) behind a defense that allowed just 15 FD's and 260 yds. The Titans have struggled in ssn openers failing to cover 5 of their past 6 while the Giants have shown some recent success as a NDIV AD with a solid 16-7 ATS mark. Despite those factors, we expect the Titans to control the clock here by doing what they do best in running the ball! With the Giants also severely banged-up to start the season on both sides of the ball under a new HC staff, this could get rough rather quickly. FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 16 3★ New Orleans over ATLANTA - Big changes for the Falcons as they enter the '22 campaign without QB Matt Ryan for the first time since '08 (FA addition Marcus Mariota expected to start). The Saints meanwhile will start with Jameis Winston under center for a 2nd straight year although he is coming off an ACL. In their Wk 18 trip to ATL a year ago, the Saints (-3') picked up a 30-20 victory finishing with 22-13 FD and 369-257 yard edges. The road team in this series has picked up 5 victories over the past 6 matchups (SU & ATS) while the Falcons are 0-4 ATS as a HD and 0-6 ATS in ssn openers. With the Saints covering 11 of their past 15 against NFC South foes, we're counting on the visitor to FORECAST: New Orleans by 14 get the job done in this one by at least a pair of TD's. OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ ARIZONA over Kansas City - The Chiefs have arguably one of the toughest schedules to start an season in NFL history with 7 consec matchups against opponents that finished with a winning record a year ago. ARZ meanwhile has started off strong in each of the past 2 seasons before struggles in the 2H of the year. In their Arrowhead trip back in '18, the Cardinals (+16) dropped a 26-14 contest with a 330-260 yard disadvantage (KC has won 4 of 5 dating back to '02). While the Chiefs have covered 6 of their past 9 road openers, keep in mind that they have a huge Thur night matchup on deck against the Chargers. With ARZ covering 4 of their past 5 against the AFC and going 13-5 ATS as a NDIV HD, we expect the home team to pull off the mild upset.

FORECAST: ARIZONA by 3

OTHER PLAYS

Buffalo at LA RAMS - Thursday - Huge non-conf matchup to begin the season between a pair of squads that should be in contention for a trip to this year's Super Bowl. The Rams are on a perfect 7-0 ATS run in ssn openers although they have stuggled in recents matchups against the AFC having failed to cover 9 of their L/11. In their last meeting back in '20, the Bills (-1') jumped out to a 28-3 lead in the 3Q but needed a 3-yd TD pass with :15 left to get the 3 pt victory (Bills 4-1 SU s/'04). While BUF has also gone 10-2-2 as an AD and 10-3 ATS against NFC foes, knocking off the defending Champs at home on opening night is never easy. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

Baltimore by 13 over NY JETS - Prior to LY's ssn-opening OT loss on MNF against the Raiders, BAL was an unstoppable team during Wk 1 with 5 consecutive victories and a scoring margin of 177-26 in that span! The Jets meanwhile have failed to cover 4 of their last 5 ssn openers including a 5 pt defeat LY in Charlotte. The Ravens have come out victorious in 9 of their past 10 meetings with the Jets dating back to 2000. Their most recent matchup came back in '19 with BAL (-16') picking up the 42-21 win (23-13 FD & 430-310 yd edges). While BAL has gone 0-5 ATS as an AF, we're backing them here as the Jets have covered just 3 of their past 9 when listed as a HD and may be without their young signal-caller Zach Wilson who is rehabbing pressn knee surgery.

MIAMI by 6 over New England - While the start of last ssn was a rough one for the Dolphins as they opened up at 1-7, the 2H of the '21 saw them pick up wins in 8 of their final 9 (7-2 ATS) to fall just short of earning one of the final WC spots in the AFC. LY also happened to be the first time since 2000 that the Dolphins picked up a ssn sweep of the Patriots with a 17-16 (+3) victory in the opener and a 33-24 (+6) win in the ssn finale. Although the Patriots (8-3 overall ATS run) did earn a postssn berth a year ago, we expect the Dolphins to get the job done in this one as they have covered 7 of their past 9 ssn openers while also going 9-3-2 ATS as home chalk.

CAROLINA by 6 over Cleveland - Well it didn't take long for Baker Mayfield to face his former team

as the Browns head to Charlotte having failed to record a victory in 17 consecutive season openers (0-16-1 SU, 5-11-1 ATS). The Browns have actually covered 7 of their past 9 meetings with the NFC but it's also worth mentioning that they'll be starting bkp QB Jacoby Brissett in this one with Deshaun Watson susp for the first 11 contests. In their most recent matchup back in '18, the Browns (+1) overcame 22-12 FD and 393-348 yd deficits to pick up the 26-20 victory. While the Panthers have failed to cover 7 straight coming in and 10 of their L/12 as a HF, CLE's consistent struggles in the opener has us on the side of the home squad.

CINCINNATI by 4 over Pittsburgh - Big changes for the Steelers as they head to Cincy without the services of Big Ben for the first time since 2003. The Bengals meanwhile have a ton of momentum heading into 2022 following a long playoff run that actually saw them leading the Rams in the 4Q of the Super Bowl in an eventual 3 pt defeat. The Bengals actually picked up the 2-game sweep over the Steelers for the first time since 2009 including a 41-10 home blowout late in the year (25-16 FD & 370-301 yd edges). While the Bengals are on a 4-1-1 ATS run against AFC North foes, PIT has had some success as a DIV AD with a 11-5 ATS mark and still have some talent on both sides of the ball to stay within the line.

San Francisco by 10 over CHICAGO - This marks the 2nd consecutive year that the 49ers head to the Midwest to begin their season (escaped with an 8 pt win LY vs DET). The Bears meanwhile get a Wk 1 home matchup for the first time in 3 years. In their Soldier Field meeting a year ago, the 49ers (-4) overcame a 13-9 HT deficit in the eventual 11 pt victory (467-324 yd edge). The Bears have fàiléd to cover 8 of their last 12 coming in while also going just 1-5 ATS as a HD. The 49ers meanwhile have covered 7 of their L/9 overall dating back to LY while going 15-7 ATS as NDIV away chalk. With SF just a win away from reaching the Super Bowl a year ago, we're expecting them to

get a DD victory in this one against CHI rookie HC Matt Eberflus. **DETROIT by 1 over Philadelphia** - The Eagles head into Ford Field having covered 6 of their past 9 ssn openers. DET meanwhile finished LY on a 7-2 ATS run that included a trio of outright upsets (MIN, ARZ, GB). The Lions did however have some major issues in LY's home meeting with PHI who picked up an easy 44-6 blowout with 27-15 FD and 350-228 yard edges. That win by the Eagles snapped a 3-game DET winning streak that dates back to '15. While PHI has also gone 6-3 ATS in ssn openers, they have struggled in the NDIV AF role covering just 3 of their last 10. With DET eager to put together a better showing against the Eagles this time around along with a 7-2 ATS as a HD, a home upset could be a possibility

Indianapolis by 10 over HOUSTON - The Colts appeared to be a lock for a WC spot in the AFC a year ago before a pair of surprising losses to the Raiders (-8) and Jaguars (-14') to close out the year. The Texans meanwhile appear to be one of the weakest teams in the NFL heading into 2022. In their 2 meetings a year ago, the Colts outscored the Texans by a 62-3 clip (swept the series each of the past 2 years). While HOU has covered 6 of their L/8 overall against AFC South foes, they have gone just 1-4 ATS in home openers. With the Colts going 8-4 ATS as an AF and having more consistency under center with veteran Matt Ryan, the visitor gets the DD lean in this one.

WASHINGTON by 6 over Jacksonville - The Jaguars return to action with a new HC in Doug Pederson who won a Super Bowl with the Eagles back in '17. They did however fail to cover 7 of their L/8 to close out last season. The Commanders meanwhile have a new QB under center in Carson Wentz who is with his 3rd team in as many years. WAS is just 1-6 ATS in home openers while also failing to cover 4 of their past 5 against the AFC. In their most recent meeting back in '18, WAS (+7') picked up a 16-13 upset of the Jags with a GW 36-yd FG as time expired (WAS 6-1 vs JAX all-time). While the Commanders have failed to cover 7 of their L/10 as home chalk, keep in mind that JAX is not only 3-8 ATS as a NDIV AD but have also failed to cover 29 of their L/33 against NFC foes. LA CHARGERS by 2 over Las Vegas - It's revenge time for the Chargers who fell just short of a playoff appearance a year ago with an OT loss to the Raiders in the ssn finale (LAC 440-346 yd edge). The home team has won and covered 3 of the last 4 including a MNF win by the Chargers in the early part of '22. While the Chargers have gone 6-2-2 ATS in ssn openers, they have struggled as a HF going just 7-16-1 ATS. With the Chargers also having a short week on deck with a Thur night trip to Arrowhead and the Raiders 11-6 ATS as an AD, we'll go ahead and call for the visitor to stay within a FG in this one (LV 8-1 ATS in road openers).

MINNESOTA by 3 over Green Bay - While 4-time NFL MVP Aaron Rodgers has had his way with NFC North foes CHI and DET with a combined 40-11 mark, the Vikings have played the All-Pro much tougher in his HOF career with GB going just 16-10-1 in his tenure including a 34-31 defeat LY in MIN (GW 29-vd FG as time expired). Although the Packers have gone an impressive 11-4-1 ATS overall heading in, they have failed to cover 5 of their L/6 when listed as away chalk. With the Vikings posting a solid 17-6 ATS mark as a HD and covering 6 of their L/7 home openers, we're giving them an excellent shot of picking up the outright upset in this one (GB 38-3 loss as 3' pt favorite in LY's Wk 1 meeting vs the Saints)

Tampa Bay at DALLAS - SNF - This marks the 2nd consecutive year that the Bucs and Cowboys face-off in the season opener. In LY's matchup in Tampa, the Cowboys (+8) nearly pulled off an upset of the defending Champs (DAL 30-24 FD & 451-431 yd edges) with the Bucs connecting on a 36-yd FG with :02 remaining. TB does come into action having covered 6 of their past 8 contests although they have gone just 1-4 ATS when listed as a NDIV AF. The Cowboys meanwhile are on a 16-5 ATS run overall, have picked up covers in 4 of their L/5 home openers and are a perfect 6-0 ATS when listed as a HD. Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner! Denver at SEATTLE - MNF - Rematch of SBXLVIII, a contest that saw the Seahawks pick up an easy 43-8 win. The NFL schedule-makers give us a highly publicized first matchup on MNF as Russell Wilson takes on his former squad (QB here from '12-'21) with the Broncos heading into the Pacific NW having covered 5 of their L/6 against NFC foes. The Seahawks also have a QB looking for some redemption in Drew Lock (DEN QB '19-'21) who was part of the Wilson deal although he'll be holding a clipboard here with SEA opting for Wilson's backup of a year ago in Geno Smith. In their most recent matchup back in '18, the hometown Broncos (-3) finished with 25-13 FD and 470-306 yd edges in the 27-24 victory. While DEN has also gone 8-4-1 ATS as a NDIV AF, HC Pete Carroll will have his team ready with SEA going 8-3 ATS vs the AFC and covering 8 of their L/10 as a HD.
