SUPER BOWL SITUATIONS

Let's take a look at some interesting situations about Super Bowl matchups. Here are the answers to recent questions about past Super Bowls. **How does a lower seed do?** The playoffs expanded in 1990 and the NFL seeded teams 1 thru 6. In 2010 it was only the second time in 16 years that a #1 seed had failed to make the Super Bowl and the only time with a matchup between the #2 and #6 seeds. A team ranked as the #4 seed or lower has reached the Super Bowl 6 times in the last 13 years, winning it 4 times. One of the most surprising stats is that the LOWER SEED is now 10-3 SU and 11-2 ATS. **What happens when an AFC/NFC title game favorite was outgained?** Five years ago BOTH teams were outgained in the conf finals but SF was a favorite. In 2011 New England was outgained 398-330 and of course was upset. In 2010 the Pittsburgh Steelers were outgained by the NY Jets 289-287 and since 1992, only 10 teams have been outgained as favorites in the title gm and went on to play in the Super Bowl. In 2009 the New Orleans Saints were outgained 475-257 but of course went on to beat Indianapolis. The Bears were outgained in 2007 by a 364-340 edge and then lost and failed to cover vs Indy. In 2005 New England was outgained 388-322 vs PIT and won but did not cover in the SB 24-21 (-7). In 1998 Denver was outgained 370-331 and won the SB 34-19 (-7) and was outgained in '97 but won 31-24 (+11). Pittsburgh was outgained in '95 (328-285) and went on to cover the SB 27-17 (+13.5) and SF won the SB 49-26 (-18) in '94 after being outgained by 157 yds by DAL. DEN was the latest to win and cover 2Y ago in the SB (+4', 24-10 win over CAR) after being outgained by NE (336-244). In '17 the Patriots were outgained (374-344) by Jacksonville in their come-from-behind win and would later go on to lose outright in the Super Bowl as a favorite against the Eagles. TY the #1 seed 49ers were narrowly outgained (358-354) in their easy win over the Packers. Teams are 5-4 SU and 6-3 ATS (dog is 4-1 ATS). **Thinking about a record?** The most combined total points in a Super Bowl came in SB 29 as SF and SD combined for 75 pts. 2017's PHI/NE matchup nearly reached the mark at 74 pts followed by 69 total pts twice as DAL defeated BUF and TB beat OAK. TY's opening total for the 49ers and Chiefs is 54. The fewest points scored had previously been 1975 when PIT and MIN combined for 22 pts in SB 9 while MIA and WAS combined for 21 pts in SB 7. However, LY's meeting between the Patriots and Rams set a new record at just 16 com pts. **Quick starts?** The final thing we'll look at is how teams have started and scored in the 1Q. It has been slow going as in the last 21 Super Bowls only THREE TIMES have the teams combined for over 10 total points in the opening period (PHI/NE 12 pts '17). Five times in the last 19 years has seen a 3-0 score after 1Q and on 5 occasions (incl LY) both teams failed to score. **GOTTA LOVE THOSE PROPS!!** Over the last 12 seasons we've had solid success with our Super Bowl prop plays. In fact we are now 108-69 (61%) on those releases!

GAME OVERVIEW - Following an impressive 17 pt home victory over the Packers where we picked up a 3★ Newsletter Winner on the "Over" and a 3★ LP Winner on the side, the 49ers are headed to their 7th Super Bowl in franchise history although their last appearance (XLVII) against the Ravens in '13 was the first time that they failed to raise the Lombardi Trophy. The Chiefs meanwhile have earned a berth in the "Big Game" for the 1st time in 50 yrs (Won SB IV vs MIN, lost SB I vs GB) after a 35-24 victory over the Titans where they held the NFL's leading rusher Derrick Henry to just 69 yds on 19 att (3.6). The past 10 SB's have seen a 5-5 split between the NFC & AFC. The favorite has gone just 7-11 SU/5-13 ATS with the score going "Over" in 6 of the L/9.

RECORD VS THE SPREAD - The 49ers earned the #1 seed in the NFC with a 13-3 SU mark while going 9-6-1 ATS. They have however cashed both of their playoff matchups with relative ease following a pair of 17 pts victories over MIN (-7) and GB (-7). The Chiefs were 12-4 during the regular ssn to finish as the #2 seed in the AFC (11-5-1 ATS). They have however covered 8 in a row as they head into the SB (6-0 regular ssn, 2-0 postssn) with a 9 pt avg cover in that span. SF and KC had similar marks away from home TY at 7-1 SU & 6-2 ATS with the 49ers outscoring their foes by 9 ppg (+90 ypg) and the Chiefs finishing with a +12 ppg edge (+62 ypg).

TURF/SITE - The 49ers are headed to Miami for the 1st time since '16. In that prior trip to "South Beach", they dropped a 31-24 contest during their rough 2-14 campaign. The Chiefs meanwhile are going to Miami for the 1st time since '14 despite being in the same conf with the Dolphins. SF is over 3,000 miles away from this venue while the Chiefs cut that distance in half at just under 1,500 miles.

SLIGHT EDGE: CHIEFS
49ERS #4 OFFENSE VS CHIEFS #17 DEFENSE - The 49ers finished the regular ssn with the #4 total offense in the NFL (381 ypg) while posting an even more impressive mark in ppg at 29.9 (#2). The Chiefs meanwhile finished in the middle of the pack in yds allowed (#17, 350 ypg) although their ppg all'd was a little better at #7 in the league (19.3 ppg). In their trip to Arrowhead a ssn ago, the 49ers put up 27 pts & 406 yds in their 11 pt loss to the Chiefs. With an outstanding running game leading the way so far through the playoffs, we expect SF's offense to have similar success in this one.

LARGE EDGE: 49ERS
CHIEFS #6 OFFENSE VS 49ERS #2 DEFENSE - The Chiefs continue to dominate on the offensive side of the ball with the NFL's #6 ranked total offense (379 ypg) and #5 scoring offense (28.2). They're in for a big test in this one however as the 49ers had the NFL's #2 total defense (282 ypg) with their 19.4 ppg all'd the 8th best mark in the league. While KC was able to put up 38 pts & 384 yds a year ago in their home venue against SF, the 49ers put a lot of attention towards this unit following the '18 ssn which has translated into much stronger numbers.

EDGE: EVEN
49ERS #23 SPECIAL TEAMS VS CHIEFS #5 SPECIAL TEAMS - While both teams finished with similar production as far as the punting game was concerned, the Chiefs had a large advantage at K in '19 with Harrison Butker connecting on 34-38 regular ssn att's. Meanwhile, SF's Robbie Gould had some injuries to overcome throughout the year (missed time) and struggled from 50+ at 0-4 for the season. Small edge in the return game to KC as KR/ PR Hardman finished with 26.1/9.3 respectively while SF's James had a 21.4 avg on KR's and finished with an 8.0 mark on PR's. With KC finishing #5 in our ST rankings and SF at #23, the Chiefs get the edge.

COACHING - While Kyle Shanahan has done an outstanding job as the HC of the 49ers TY as they became the 1st team to ever reach the SB following 4 consec ssn's of DD losses (also part of 1st father/son duo to each lead their respective teams to a SB), Andy Reid is in his 21st ssn as HC overall (14-14 playoff record) with one prior trip to the SB (loss to NE in '04 as PH's HC). Reid has been coach in the NFL since Kyle Shanahan (now 41) was 13 yrs old.

EDGE: CHIEFS
PAST HISTORY MATCHUP/INTANGIBLES - The 49ers and Chiefs have met 6 time since the 2000 campaign with each team earning victories on 3 occasions. During that span, the home team has gone a perfect 6-0 with a 16 pt avg MOV. While both teams went 3-1 SU against non-conf foes TY (SF 3-1 ATS, KC 2-2 ATS), the 49ers outgained their AFC North foes by 192 ypg while KC had a +35 ypg edge against the NFC North. With this matchup being played in a neutral venue, there is no true value for either side.

EDGE: EVEN
CONCLUSION - While SF QB Jimmy Garoppolo has never seen the field in the "Big Game", he has witnessed it first hand on multiple occasions as the bkp to future HOF QB Tom Brady including a pair of Super Bowl victories. Patrick Mahomes on the other hand has guided the Chiefs to an outstanding mark over his 1st 2 years as the starter under center. While SF and KC have seen their offenses have success with vastly different schemes, both squads continue to rack up point and yards at alarming rates with the #4 and #6 offenses respectively. From the 49ers' 7th game on, the "Over" has cashed in 9 of 12 matchups with an avg of 55 pts being put up. The Chiefs meanwhile have seen their 4 playoff contests over the past 2 years avg 63 ppg including putting up 31 pts against a Patriots team a ssn ago that held the high-octane Rams to just 3 pts in the Super Bowl. With the "Over" cashing in 6 of the past 9 SB matchups and both teams finishing with nearly 30 ppg on the season, a 54 pt opening line seems quite achievable.

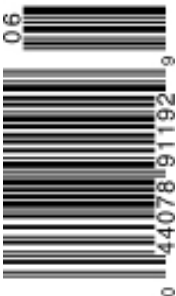
