4★ TOLEDO over San Jose St - Only previous mtg was the 1981 California Bowl that Toledo won 27-25. The last MAC foe SJSJ faced on the road was WMich in '21 and they lost 23-3 (+2) as they were -238 yards. Toledo last faced a MW team just last season as they lost at SDSJ despite being +95 yards (-3 TO's). Both teams picked up their 1st win of the season LW as Toledo beat TX Southern 71-3 while SJSJ beat Cal Poly 59-3. We see Toledo as the stronger team here, as they nearly upset Illinois on the road in their opener and overall their defense is allowing 306 ypg and have 7 sks. SJSJ's defense has struggled vs FBS foes TY as they all'd 501 to USC and 473 to Oreg St and now they have to face dynamic QB Finn and this line is just above a td as of presstime!

FORECAST: TOLEDO by 17

3★ ARKANSAS over BYU - Last year QB Jefferson returned from an injury and threw for 367 yds and 5 td's as Ark won 52-35 (E). Ark is off a flat spot where they only beat Kent St 28-6 (-38) but the Hogs were without RB Rocket Sanders. BYU has been less than impressive in their two wins, beating Sam Houston by 14 and Southern Utah by 25 but only with a 394-346 yard edge, getting a punt block, scoring td's off a blk'd punt, muffed punt and missed fg. This is a huge step up in competition for the Cougars who have faced two teams that were in the FCS last year. Ark has LSU on deck but HC Pittman is probably lighting a fire in them after not taking Kent St seriously. HC Sitake is 12-4 as an away dog but QB Slovis only had an 11-8 ratio last year at Pitt and we think Arkansas rolls here.

FORECAST: ARKANSAS by 20

3★ Kansas St over MISSOURI - These former Big 12 foes have met 98 times (Mizzou leads 60-33-5) and their last meeting came LY where the KSt (-7) led 20-3 HT despite just a +31 yd edge (punt return TD KSt) and won 40-12 (+114 yds, +3 TO's). This is KSt's road opener and beat Troy last wk 42-13, while Mizzou is at home for a 3rd straight game and they hung on to beat Middle Tenn 23-19. Mizzou comes into this matchup with the edge in experience (#8 vs #85) as QB Cook is the main starter and is hitting 78%. KSt QB Howard is hitting 67% while RB's Giddens (180, 6.7) and Ward (114, 4.2) are a great 1-2 punch. KSt's defense has 8 sks in 2 gm's & held their F/2 foes to under 300 yds. Mizzou did allow 235 rush (5.5) to KSt LY but that was on the road & LY Mizzou held foes to 97 rush ypg (2.9) at home. These teams appear to be close on paper, but we have been more impressed by KSt early this ssn and we'll call for KSt, who is 4-1 ATS as an AF under Klieman, to pull out the win by almost 2 td's.

FORECAST: Kansas St by 13

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ OREGON ST over San Diego St - 6th meeting all-time. Last met back in 2014 here and Oregon St (-10) outgained SDSJ by 157 yds in a 28-7 win. The Beavers are 2-0 after a 55-7 win over UC Davis while SDSJ lost 35-10 to UCLA last week which cashed us a 4★ Totals LPS. SDSJ allowed 550 yds and now face an OSU offense led by QB Ulagalelei (74%, 5-0) and RB Martinez (249, 10.0). SDSJ's offense usually relies on the run game & vs 2 FBS foes TY they have ran for 104 ypg and QB Mayden is hitting just 56% with a 3-3 ratio. OSU has allowed just 279 & 166 yds in their F/2 gms, plus have 6 sks. This is the Aztecs first road game of the season and they do have a marquee MW matchup against Boise on deck. Plus OSU has the experience edge (#37 vs #87), and while this line is over 3 td's, it is impossible for us to go against Oregon St here as they are on a 11-1 ATS run as a home favorite and have covered 14 straight games overall at home!

FORECAST: OREGON ST by 31

2★ BUFFALO by 3 over Liberty - Liberty first trip to Buffalo. Flames lead series 2-0 including their only meeting as FBS foes in '19 when Liberty won 35-17 as a 5' pt HD. After only trailing a ranked Wisconsin team 14-10 at HT and easily covering in the opener, the Bulls for a 2nd straight season gave up a late score and lost to an FCS foe. Liberty is just 2-6 as an AF since '21 (UB 2-0 as HD since LY). While Liberty has the edges on both OFF (#87-#110) & DEF (#94-#115), this is their first road trip this year under a new HC. Last year Buffalo was off a loss to FCS Holy Cross and covered against HC Chadwell's Coastal Carolina team. We think the Bulls pull out all the stops here and we are calling for the home upset.

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY 9/14

MEMPHIS by 21 Navy - These teams have met every year since 2015 and Memphis has won 5 of 8 and have covered 3 of the last 4. Memphis enters this one 2-0 (1-1 ATS) after a 37-3 (-21) road win over Arkansas St. The Tiger held Ark St to just 230 total yards, including just 64 on the ground and has now allowed 58 ypg rushing in their first 2. QB Seth Henigan was an efficient 21-29 for 239 and 2 tds and is now completing 73.8% on the year with a 4-2 ratio. Navy is off a uninspiring 24-0 (-41) win over FCS Wagner to move to 1-1 (0-2) on the year. After passing for just 43 yards in their opener, the Midshipmen did get the pass game going a bit in this one. QB Lavatai hit 8-13 for 161 and a td and was also the #2 rusher with 65 (4.1). The Navy defense held the Seahawks to 227 yards. The home team is on a 4-1 ATS run and Navy is still trying to get their offense full untracked, so we like the Tigers by over 3 tds in this one.

FRIDAY 9/15

MARYLAND by 20 over Virginia - These former ACC rivals meet up for the first time since 2013. Virginia may have fell short of pulling the upset vs James Madison last week, losing 36-35 (+6) but they also found their QB. Transfer QB Tony Muskett sat out so true frosh Anthony Colandrea got the start and threw for 377 yards and 2 td's. The Cavaliers led JMU 35-24 but allowed the go-ahead td with :55 left and was SOD. Maryland enters 2-0 after wins over Towson and Charlotte. The Terps (-24) trailed CLT 14-0 1Q last week but scored the next 38 points and gave up a backdoor cover with 1:22 left. MD has the experience edge (#68 vs #106) and this could be Colandrea's first road start but MD only has one home win by more than 21 points in the last two years. The defenses and ST's are even and MD gets the edge on offense and Colandrea may be making his first road start.

UTSA by 8 over Army - 4th mtg. Army won & covered the first 2 mtgs, but UTSA won last year's 41-38 shoot-out at West Point. These 2 teams combined for almost 1,000 total yards as Army threw for a season high 304 pass yards. The Black Knights are 1-1 after their 57-0 (-39) beatdown of FCS for Delaware St in which they outgained the Hornets 525-219. Army featured a balanced attack with 287 rush (6.7) and 238 pass yards. UTSA sits at 1-1 (0-2 ATS) coming off their 20-13 (-14) home win over Texas St. The Roadrunners have yet to get their offense in rhythm and they are averaging just 17 ppg after scoring 37 ppg last season. Their defense has been solid, allowing 288 ypg including just 66 ypg (2.0) on the ground and has 9 sacks. The home team has yet to cover in the series and Army is a pesky underdog, so we'll side with a Black Knights squad that's getting double-digits.

AIR FORCE by 13 over Utah St - From 2015-2020 AF was 5-1 SU/5-0-1 ATS against USU but in their past 2 meetings USU has covered AND pulled the outright upset winning 49-45 (+9) in '21 and 34-27 (+11) last season. AF is off a 10-pt win in Texas against Sam Houston where they held them to 80 total yards & 3 pts while USU put up 591 yards and 78 pts on Idaho St! Through 2 gms AF's option attack is still rolling (309, 5.4) despite new starters at both QB and FB as new QB Larrier has ran for 164 (5.0). While USU hasn't exactly been able to stop the run vs AF the L2Y (264 in '22, 437 in '21) they put up 414 yds LY and 628 in '21, both totals were season-highs for AF in yards allowed. USU HC Anderson seems to have his team playing their best vs AF the Vegas line as of presstime was single digits and we see AF winning here by nearly 2 td's as their defense has been dominant early on this season.

SATURDAY 9/16

WISCONSIN by 20 over Georgia Southern - 1st meeting, but GA Southern is no stranger in B10 country as they pulled a 45-42 outright upset at Nebraska last year as 23' point road dog. The Eagles enter this one at 2-0 SU/ATS off their 49-35 (-7) win over UAB. GA Southern was outgained 477-462, but forced 3 Blazer TO's. QB Davis Brin (a Tulsa transfer) threw for 318 (81%) and 2 tds. Wisconsin fell 31-22 (-6) at Washington St last week, despite outgaining Wazzu 368-332. The Badgers have yet to get their new spread, tempo offense fully engaged. They were held to 90 yards rushing (3.1) and QB Mordecai was sacked 3 times. The Wisky defensive line did show signs of life with 4 sacks, after not recording one in the opener. The Badgers have their B10 opener on deck and need to get their offense fully engaged and with think they do that here.

Florida St by 21 over BOSTON COLLEGE - FSU is 11-1 SU/8-4 ATS and has won & covered the last 4 in this series. Last year the 'Noles dominated BC in the 1H, led 31-0 with a 327-64 yard edge and won by 30. The previous three meetings were all decided by 7 points or less. BC is just 4-7 ATS vs ranked foes but FSU has a huge game vs Clemson on deck so this is a big look-ahead spot. The 'Noles didn't have a letdown last week vs SMiss, winning 66-13 (-31). They had a 290-70 yd edge at half. BC took Holy Cross' best shot last week and won 31-28 (-10'). FSU has huge edges on both offense and defense but will be an extra crowd edge on Red Bandana Day, honoring 9-11 hero Welles Crowther. With an extra motivated BC team catching FSU in a flat spot we will side with the underdog and cut our lean off at 3 td's and Hafley is 7-4 as a HD.

Wake Forest by 12 over OLD DOMINION - The only prior meeting between these two came in '21 when ODU was only -80 yds and -3 FD's but allowed a KR td, 2 TO's and were SOD 3x. ODU has already lost to an ACC foe this year when we cashed our first 4★ on these pages in week 1, losing 36-17 (+16). ODU does have two home upsets over VTech since '18 and only lost to UVA 16-14 (+8) last year. Last week WF had a 484-423 yd edge and were +2 TO's, beating Vandy 36-20 (-10). ODU was one of the youngest teams in the country (7 ret str's) but showed significant improvement in game 2, upsetting LA 38-31 (+5). QB Grant Wilson was held under 100 pass yds vs VTech two weeks ago but threw for 247 and 4 td's last week and faces WF's pass D which gave up 314 and 3 td's to Vandy. WF is just 5-10 as an AF and ODU will have an excited home crowd coming off a win so we could see this finishing closer than expected. WF is avg 37 ppg and ODU's OC had the #1 offense in the FCS last year. This could be high scoring and in the mix for our Totals GOM!

† Louisville by 13 over Indiana - Indianapolis. This game is being played at Lucas Oil Field in Indianapolis. They haven't met since 1986 when Indiana won 21-0 (-13') and UL has played just one Big 10 team since 2002, beating Purdue 35-28 (-25) in '17. Both teams come off lopsided wins over FCS foes. UL beat Murray St 56-0 (-43') but failed to cover as a 7' pt fav vs GTEch in the opener. Indiana beat an Indiana St squad that was missing their starting QB 41-7 (-30'). The Hoosiers split time with 2 QB's, with Tayven Jackson looking impressive (18-21-236). UL has the edge on offense but QB Plummer has thrown 3 int's in their first two games and their D showed some areas of concern in the opener, allowing 488 yds. It's hard to gauge what Indiana's offense is going to be, getting shutdown by OSU in the opener and playing an FCS foe last week. The Cardinals have the experience edge (#70 vs #123) and HC Brohm covered all 5 meetings vs the Hoosiers during his time at Purdue.

Iowa St by 3 over OHIO - 9th meeting all-time, only ISU's 2nd trip to Athens. First was in 2001 when ISU (E) held on to win 31-28 after leading Ohio 31-14 entering the 4Q. Ohio came into the season #23 in experience, returning 15 str's including MAC POY QB Rourke, but last week was his first full game after missing most of the F/2 gms. WR's Wiglusz and Jones (#1 and #2 WR's from LY) have also missed time this season. ISU has dealt with their fair share of issues coming into the season and are off Iowa where they lost 20-13 despite holding Iowa to 235 yds (Iowa pick-6). RS frosh QB Becht is the new starter but the offense is only avg'g 270 ypg, but the D is holding tms to 257 ypg. ISU HC Campbell is just 2-5 ATS as an AF since '21 and Ohio was 3-0 ATS as a home dog LY and we think the Bobcats at home can keep this game close.

Penn St by 10 over ILLINOIS - These teams last met in 2021 and it proved to be a memorable afternoon as the Illini outlasted the Nittany Lions 20-18 (+24) in an epic 9 OT affair. The game was tied at just 10-10 entering overtime and Illinois controlled the action the majority of the day as they had a commanding 395-227 yardage edge. The Illini are 1-1 (0-2 ATS) after their 34-23 (+3') loss at Kansas last Friday. Illinois has yet to get their ground game going, as QB Luke Altmyer is the leading rusher with 139 (6.3) but 76 came on one td run last week. After allowing just 13 ppg LY, Illinois is allowing 31 ppg so far TY. PSU mashed FCS foe Delaware 63-7 last week as the Nittany Lions scored on 6 of their first 7 possessions and had a commanding 20-2 first down edge at HT. The PSU is allowing just 224 ypg and has 7 sacks through the first 2 weeks. Illinois HC Bielema is 5-2 ATS as a DD dog here with 2 outright upsets, so we'll take the Illini to keep this one within the line that opened at over 2 tds.

Lsu by 6 over MISSISSIPPI ST - LSU is 13-2 SU/12-3 ATS in Starkville. Last year MSU had a 13-0 lead but was SOD 3x, fumbled a punt and had an 88 yd KR td called back as they lost 31-16 (-3). The Tigers were off a loss last week and took no mercy on FCS Grambling, winning 72-10, though they did only lead 14-10 after the 1Q. MSU led AZ 14-0 2Q, had a td called back, missed a fg then AZ went 77 yds on 3 plays just before half. The Bulldogs led 21-7 Q but had to pull it out in OT 31-24 (-9). QB Rogers threw 3 td's but only had 17 pass attempts. MSU is only 1-7 as a home dog and LSU already has a loss but this is Brian Kelly's first time dealing with the cow-bells and LSU was 0-3 as an AF last year. We think the Tigers get the win but the Bulldogs keep it within a td.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 6 over Massachusetts - While UMass won both MAC meetings ('14 & '15), since they left the conference EM has won both meetings but was a 20+ favorite in both & failed to cover. In fact UMass is 4-0 ATS in series. LW EMich once again delivered in roll as a dog not only giving us a Power Sweep Underdog POW winner but also a 3★ Late Phone winner despite Minnesota up 22-6 kicking a "meaningless" FG with :29 left for a 25-6 win as a 20 pt HF. While they excel as a dog, EM is just 1-7 as a HF since '21 including only getting by Howard 33-23 as a 24 pt HF in this year's opener. UMass after winning their opener 41-30 as a 7 pt AD at New Mexico St, they have lost their last 2 SU & ATS including a 41-28 loss to Miami, OH last week as a 7 pt HF. EM has the defensive edge (#107-#126) but UMass has the Offensive edge (#120-#126) & EM struggles as a favorite.

MICHIGAN by 41 over Bowling Green - 1st meeting since 2010 and Michigan is 2-0 SU/ATS in the series. The Wolverines are 11-0 SU and 8-3 ATS vs MAC teams since 2008. Michigan has put in 2 workmanlike performances with easy wins over 2 non-POWER 5 foes, they are 0-2 ATS. QB JJ McCarthy has thrown for 558 while hitting 87.3% of his passes with a 5-0 ratio. The Michigan defense has allowed just 10 points through 2 weeks, while allowing just 232 ypg. Bowling Green is 1-1 off their 38-15 (-19) win over FCS Eastern Illinois. The Falcons outgained EIU 509-325 as QB Connor Bazelak hit 23-28 for 319 and a 3-0 ratio. Michigan beat up non-conf foes last year with an average margin of victory of almost 50, but have not been nearly as impressive so far this year so while the Wolverines will role here, we're just not sure if they cover the line that is around 6 tds.

New Mexico St by 3 over NEW MEXICO - NM leads the Rio Grande Rivalry 73-34-5 and the NMSt pulled the upset as 7 point dogs last year, 21-9 and the Aggies have covered 6 of the last 7. Jerry Kill's squad led Liberty 17-13 last week but were shutout the rest of the way and lost 33-17 (+10). Last week vs Tenn Tech NM put up their most pts (56) and yards (589) in Danny Gonzales' tenure. NMSt is averaging 483 ypg including 217 rush (6.3). The offense looks improved under new OC Bryant Vincent who brought QB Hopkins with him from UAB. NM is just 3-19-1 ATS vs FBS foes since 2019 and we are calling for the Aggies to pull the upset. This game has gone Over the Vegas Total in 7 of the last 9 meetings, averaging 67.4 ppg so this game will be worth of a look for our September Totals 4.5★ GOM!

NOTRE DAME by 35 over Central Michigan - First mtg. Look in the dictionary under flatspot and you will see this game listed, Notre Dame is 3-0, ranked in the Top 10 is off a road win over an ACC foe and has a home game against a Top 10 Ohio State team they lost to last year on deck. They have opened as a 14 pt AD in the opener and just getting by an FCS team (a ranked FCS team) by 3 pts LW as a 7 pt HF. Notre Dame is 3-0 SU & ATS including an easy cover LW as Our top College Late Phone play covering by 14 pt, 45-24 as a 7 pt AF. Last year the Irish were just 1-4 ATS as a HF including outright losses to Marshall & Stanford. They have won & covered their last 2 in the role including 2 wks ago covering 56-3 as a 48' pt HF over Tenn St. The Irish have huge talent edges to easily cover here and have now covered 9 of their last 10 so despite the look ahead we side with ND.

RUTGERS by 9 over Virginia Tech - 1st meeting s/12. Rutgers is off to a 2-0 for the 3rd straight year after their 36-7 (-8) home win over Temple. The Scarlet Knights stuck with a conservative plan as they ran for 254 on 52 carries (4.9) and let their defense go to work. Rutgers allowed just 68 (2.8) rush yards and is allowing just 40 rush ypg so far. V.Tech endured a 6 hour weather delay at home vs Purdue last week, then came back from 17 down to tie the game only to fall 24-17 (-1) as they were outgained 427-286 as QB Grant Wells threw 2 ints and was sacked 3 times. V.Tech was 2-4 ATS on the road in HC Pry's first year and this one is essentially a toss-up, so we'll side with the home team as these are the types of games Rutgers needs to win if they hope to go bowling this season.

CONNECTICUT by 8 over FIU - Last year in their only prior meeting Huskies as a 5' pt AF, were outgained 409-402 but were +3 TO's. FIU is 2-1 for the first time s/18. In a game that had 11 lead changes FIU almost blew an 11 pt 4Q lead allowing 2 td's in a 1:15 span to trail 39-38 but answered with a 75 yd td drive for a 46-39 upset of North Texas as an 11 pt HD. UConn after only losing to NC State by 10 as a 14 pt HD struggled in their road opener as they trailed at Georgia St 28-0 into 4Q as a 3 pt AD and lost 35-14. They did lose starting QB Fagnano to injury in the 2Q as UConn was outgained 247-88 in the 1H. FIU frosh QB Jenkins threw for 291 yds and is the highest rated recruit in school history. The Panthers did pull two outright road upsets last year and are +10 here so we will lean with the dog.

Alabama by 35 over USF - This is Bama's first road trip to a Power-5 foe since 1992 when they won 37-0 at Tulsa. Bama has won 41 straight vs non-P5's but are only 19-21 ATS in those wins. USF was outgained last week vs FCS FAMU 393-342 but were +5 TO's and won 38-24 (-18). Bama has covered just 2 of their last 7 as road favorites but those were all in much more hostile environments. Bama may have lost at Texas last week, but we wouldn't write off the Tide who still has plenty to play for with a full SEC schedule awaiting them. USF HC Goleish was the OC at Tenn when the Vols upset Bama last year but he doesn't have the skill players on this squad, with QB Byrum Brown completing just 51.5% and makes his first start vs a P5. While Bama has Ole Miss on deck, Saban will have the Tide playing better off a loss and they have covered 5 of their last 6 off a loss.

APPALACHIAN ST by 6 over East Carolina - These former FCS conference foes meet for just the 2nd time in FCS foes. Last meeting was the '21 opener in Charlotte and App St led 20-6 at HT and won 33-19 (+104 yds, +5 FD's). App St lost QB Burger in the 1H of the opener, but QB Aguilar threw 4 td's in that game & last week threw for 275 yds in App St's 40-34 double OT loss at UNC. This is ECU's 3rd straight tough non-conf game after losing at Mich 30-3 in Week 1 and losing 31-13 last wk to Marshall. ECU's offense has failed to top 270 yds in their F/2 gms, but App St all'd 360 to GWebb and 527 to UNC. App St is 6-13 as a HF while ECU is on a 12-4 run as an AD so we'll favor the Pirates in this game.

NORTH CAROLINA by 11 over Minnesota - First meeting. Battle of 2-0 teams. NC has a huge experience edge (#6 vs #93). For the 2nd straight season the Heels barely avoided being upset by App State, winning 40-34 in 2 OT. Minn is allowing just 224 yards in their first 2 games but are clearly facing the best offense they've seen. The Gophers were fortunate to beat Nebraska at home in week 1 and didn't cover as 20 pt favorites last week vs EMich, winning 25-6. NC did beat South Carolina in their opener by 14 points but a week after posting 9 sacks vs the Gamecocks, they had 0 vs App St last week. Everyone will talk about Drake May but NC has focused on the run in the offseason and Omarion Hampton had 234 yards and 3 td's last week. The Gophers are 0-5 SU/1-4 ATS on the road vs ranked foes and we will go with the better QB at home in this one.

DUKE by 18 over Northwestern - These teams have met each of the last 2 years and Duke has won and covered both, including a 30-23 (+2) win LTH here in 2021 and the dog is on a 9-1 ATS run. The Dukies are still riding high off their opening week upset over Clemson and took down FCS Lafayette 42-7 last week, despite leading just 21-7 at HT with only 272-155 yard edge. The Blue Devil defense bore down in the 2H and allowed just 58 total yards. Northwestern is off a 38-7 (E) home win over UTEP to move to 1-1 (1-1 ATS). The Miners scored on their opening drive, but the Wildcats pitched a shutout the rest of the way. Wildcats starting QB Ben Bryant did injure his shoulder late in the 3Q (CS). Duke has not been an 20+ point favorite vs another Power 5 team since 1978 so this is an unfamiliar role and we just think the line is a little too high so we'll take Northwestern with the points.

IOWA by 34 over Western Michigan - 1st meeting since 2013. Iowa is 25-4 SU and 7-10 ATS vs MAC tms and have covered the last 3. WMU last beat a Big10 foe back in 2016 and have gone 0-5 SU/ATS in those matchups since, including a 35-13 (+1) loss at Mich St last season. The Broncos were throttled 48-7 (+24) at Syracuse last week. WMU got a 75 yd TD rush by Jalen Buckley on their 2nd play of the game to take a 7-0 lead, but were outscored 48-0 the rest of the way as they only managed 243 total yds after that run. Iowa is 2-0 (1-1 ATS) off a hard fought 20-13 (-4) win over in-state rival Iowa St, despite being outgained 290-235. The Hawkeyes led 17-3 at HT in large part due to a pick-6 by DB Sebastian Castro. Iowa needs to score more points, especially heading into B10 play to next week against Penn St and we think they score early and often against a defense with only 2 starters back from last year that allowed almost 500 yards last week.

GEORGIA by 21 over South Carolina - UGA has won 7 of the last 8 meetings but the home team is 0-7 ATS. SC is actually the last road team to win in Sanford Stadium back in '19. Last year UGA led 48-0 and SC's only td came with :53 left. Both teams have battled injuries early in the season. UGA has scored just 7 points in the 1Q vs UT Martin and Ball St. South Carolina trailed Furman (#6 in FCS) 14-7 2Q but scored 2 td's in the last :43 of the 1H and eventually led 47-14 before allowing a late td. QB Rattler has thrown for 698 yds in 2 games and a week after allowing 9 sacks to NC, they only gave up 1 last week. SC's lack of run game (53 rush ypg, 1.5) is a huge concern against UGA's

D but this line will be inflated and don't forget SC did have a 17-14 lead vs NC at half in the opener. Rattler has yet to commit a TO and we think he will make enough plays to keep it close while UGA's slow starts has us siding with the dog.

OKLAHOMA ST by 7 over South Alabama - 3rd meeting. OSU won and covered in both 2017 (44-7 win as 28-pt favorite) and 2018 (55-13 win as 31.5-pt favorite). SAAla is off a 35-17 win vs SELA while Okla St went to Ariz St last week and held them to 277 yds and won 27-15. Okla St's defense the F/2 gms has held tms to 334 ypg and collected 8 sks. SAAla has the huge edge in experience (#4 vs #116), but the defense is allowing 424 ypg and their pass D has all'd 322 ypg (77%) but the Cowboys are trying to figure out who their full-time starting QB will be and could be playing 3 QB's like they have the F/2 games. Okla St does have their Big 12 opener on deck at Iowa St and only beat FCS Central Arkansas at home by 14 pts two weeks ago.

Oklahoma by 34 over TULSA - OU has won 20 of the 28 meetings all-time including the past 9 games. Last met in 2015 (OU won 52-38) and last met here the year before in 2014 where the #4 Sooners won 52-7 (-24). Tulsa is playing their 2nd straight Power 5 foe after losing to Wash last week 43-10, while OU led SMU just 14-11 4Q last week before 2 td's in the L/10 min to win 28-11. Tulsa's pass defense was torched LW by Wash, allowing 454 pass yds and OU QB Gabriel is hitting 78% with a 6-0 ratio. With Tulsa coming into TY under a new HC and only 7 total starters back, we expected growing pains. While OU has their Big 12 opener on deck, they blew out Ark St 73-0 and have won 4 non-conf reg ssn gms under HC Venables by 30+ points. There could also be a large group of OU fans on hand and we see the Sooners rolling by nearly 5 td's.

OHIO ST by 24 over Wku - 1st mtg. OSU is 15-0 SU vs non-P5 teams since 2015, but just 8-7 ATS. WKU is 0-11 all-time vs Power 5 schools, but did almost upset Indiana last season when they lost 33-30 in OT as a 6' point dog. WKU enters this one at 2-0 (1-1 ATS) following their 52-22 (-41) win over FCS foe Houston Christian. QB Austin Reed has thrown for 589 (67.5%) with a 6-0 ratio the first 2 weeks. Ohio St seemed to be going through the motions for much of their 35-7 (-44) win over FCS Youngstown St, although they did get WR Marvin Harrison going after a quiet week 1. Harrison caught td passes of 71 and 39 and finished with 7-160 (22.9) as QB McCord hit 14-20 for 258 and 3 tds. WKU HC Tyson Helton is 0-5 ATS as a double-digit dog, but we think the Hilltoppers keep this one within the line, especially with the Buckeyes potentially looking ahead to their showdown with Notre Dame next week.

TEXAS A&M by 41 over ULM - A&M has won all 3 recent meetings, 2-1 ATS and in '18 they won 48-10 (-27). The Aggies were -3 last week and led 17-7 2Q but lost 48-33. They did only get outgained 451-433 and QB Weigman threw for 336 yards. ULM upset Army in the opener but only beat Lamar 24-14 (-28) last week. A&M's offense has looked the part in the first two weeks and ULM is likely to have the success that Miami did passing. ULM does their best work as a home dog but are only 4-9 as a road dog under Bowden. A&M has Auburn on deck, but there may be some line value with ULM coming in 2-0 for the first time since '18 and A&M is angry off the loss. Last year ULM lost by 42 at Texas and 56 at Bama while A&M already has a 42 point win over NMex this year so this could get ugly fast.

Tulane by 14 over SOUTHERN MISS - These teams have met 3 of the last 4 years and Tulane has won and covered in 2 of those, although Southern Miss did pull a 27-24 (+12.5) upset at Tulane last year. Tulane is just 1-6 SU (3-4) ATS in Hattiesburg, but the lone win was a 66-24 (-3.5) blowout the LTH in 2020. Tulane QB Pratt missed last week vs Ole Miss and the Green Wave fell 37-20 (+8) despite leading 17-7 at HT. Backup Kai Horton completed 15-37 (40.5%) for 231 with 1 td but threw an int and was sacked 4 times. The Green Wave defense limited the potent Ole Miss run game to just 89 yards (2.5) and that bodes well against a So Miss team that likes to run the ball. Southern Miss is off a 66-13 (+31) shallacking at the hands of Florida St last week. The Golden Eagles were never really in the game as they trailed 31-3 at the half while being outgained 294-70. While Pratt's status is uncertain, the Green Wave will not look past a Southern Miss team that upset them last year, so we like Tulane to win and cover in Hattiesburg once again.

Washington at 21 over MICHIGAN ST - These teams met in Seattle last year and the Huskies dominated from the start in their 38-29 (-3.5) win that wasn't as close as the final score would indicated. Washington led 29-8 at HT and 39-14 early in the 4th before allowing 2 tds last in the 4th. The Huskies held the Spartans to just 42 rush yds (1.4) as they outgained MSU 503-365 as QB Michael Penix went 24-40 for 397 with 4 tds and 0 ints. Washington dismantled an outmanned Tulsa team 43-10 (-33) last week. The Huskies are averaging 566 yds per game, which is good for #6 in the NCAA. The Spartans haven't really been challenged with easy wins over Cent Michigan and FCS Richmond, although their defense has been impressive allowing just 206 ypg through 2 weeks. MSU QB Noah Kim has thrown for 571 (67.9%) with a 5-0 ratio and Connecticut transfer RB Nate Carter has 224 (6.1). Washington has edges on both sides of the ball and Penix (transfer from Indiana) has experience playing road games in the B10, so we like the Huskies by more than 3 tds vs an untested Michigan St squad.

Tennessee by 4 over FLORIDA - UT hasn't beat Florida in B2B years since '03-'04 and the Vols have lost 9 straight in 'The Swamp'. In fact, UT hasn't been favored here since 1993 (-1, lost 41-34) and now the Vols are laying a touchdown! Last year UT trailed 14-10 but went 99/12 and took the lead with :07 left in 1H. UT led 38-21 but UF scored 2 late td's and only lost 38-33 (+10). UF outgained Utah 346-270 in the opener but the crowd noise definitely affected the Gators, which led to 9 penalties and they were just 1-13 on 3rd down but they have the crowd on their side this time. The Vols enter off a lackluster win over FCS Austin Peay 30-13 (-44) and only led 13-6 at half. UF built some confidence last week, beating up on McNeese ST 49-7 (-45). HC Napier is 16-5-1 ATS as a dog. This rivalry has been so one sided (UF 15-2 SU/12-5 ATS) and we like UF's ability to stop the run (76 rush ypg all'd, 2.7) to help keep this game closer than expected.

CINCINNATI by 12 over Miami, Oh - 127th meeting of the "Battle For The Bell" and Cincy has won the last 16 meetings SU (10-6 ATS). LY Cincy (-23) led just 24-17 HT but held Miami to 67 yards and 0 points in the 2H and won 38-17. Cincy is off a road upset at Pitt, as they held them to 262 yds while Miami was at UMass last week and won 41-28. Miami all'd 250 rush yds (6.9) in their opener vs Miami, FL and Cincy has ran for 223 (5.2) ypg this season. Miami's OL has all'd 5 sks (10.9%) on the ssn and Cincy has 8 sks on the ssn (14.0%). Miami does have the large edge in experience (#15 vs #128), but this is their 3rd straight road game and while Cincy does have their Big 12 opener on deck against Oklahoma, and while the Bearcats have looked impressive early the line is over 2 td's and we think Miami can keep this game within the line.

CHARLOTTE +8 over Georgia St

CHARLOTTE over Georgia St - These teams met the last 2 years at Georgia St and they split those matchups. Charlotte pulled the upset last year (42-41 (+20) when the 49ers scored the winning td with just 17 seconds left. This, however, is a much different Charlotte squad as they have a new HC in Biff Poggi, who brought in over 40 transfers, including QB Jalon Jones from Bethune-Cookman (orig at Florida). The 49ers were impressive in the first half vs Maryland LW as they actually led 14-9 at HT as they held Maryland to just 156 yds. Unfortunately, they allowed 29 unanswered points in the 2H, before getting a td with 1:22 left for the backdoor cover in their 38-20 (+24) loss. GA State dominated UCONN from the outset in LW's 35-14 (-3) home win which moved GASU to 2-0. Georgia St is 4-2-1 as an AF under HC Elliott, but we'll call for the 49ers to get the outright win at home in their first home matchup vs an FBS foe. **FORECAST: CHARLOTTE by 3**

LOUISIANA TECH by 8 over North Texas - These teams met the last 10 seasons as members of CUSA, but this is a non-conf matchup as UNT moved to the AAC this year. LA Tech won 7 of those meetings (6-4 ATS), but N Texas won 47-27 (-6.5) last season and has covered 2 straight. N Texas is off to a disappointing 0-2 SU/ATS start under new HC Eric Morris. The Mean Green defense has been anything but mean, as they've allowed 1,183 yds over the first 2 weeks and are surrendering 52 ppg, including 46 last week to an FIU squad that avg'd just 19 ppg last season. LA Tech enters at 2-1 after a 51-21 win over FCS Northwestern St. Boise transfer QB Hank Bachmeier leads a Bulldog's offense that is averaging 398 ypg and 29 ppg. He has now thrown for 684 (67.4%) with a 3-2 ratio. LA Tech is a slight favorite at home where they are 7-1 ATS under Cumbie and we like them to cover against a UNT team still trying to find their identity under their 1st year HC.

TROY by 1 over James Madison - 3rd meeting, but first as Sun Belt foes. Prior 2 meetings came in the FCS playoffs. This would have been the Sun Belt title game last fall had JMU been eligible to play in that game. Troy is off a trip to Kansas St where they were held to 286 yds in a 42-13 loss while JMU was at Virginia and scored the GW TD with 55 sec left 4Q for the 36-35 win. Troy's offense did struggle LW but could find success passing here as JMU allowed 377 pass yds LW, but Troy did allow 4 sks LW and JMU has 7 sks on the ssn. Troy was 8-1 ATS vs SBC foes LY incl 4-1 ATS at home but JMU did cover 3 of their 4 SBC road games LY. Both teams came into '23 near each other in experience (Troy #57, JMU #68) and these teams appear even to us, so we'll call for the home team by a point.

NEBRASKA by 10 over Northern Illinois - 3rd meeting, but 1st since 2019. N Illinois actually pulled an outright upset here back in 2017, but was blownout 44-8 (-14) LTH in '19. The Huskies are off a 14-11 upset loss to FCS Southern Illinois in which they actually outgained SIU 360-219 but were -3 in TO's. The NIU defense has been solid through 2 weeks, allowing just 267 ypg. Nebraska comes in at 0-2 (1-1 ATS) after their 36-14 (+2) loss at Colorado and continue to be plagued by TO's as they are -6 TO's through 2 weeks. The Huskers only trailed 13-0 at HT and held Colorado to 150 first half, but wore down in the 2H due to being on the field too much. They have limited their opponents to just 57 rush ypg (1.9). Nebraska lost at home to a Group of 5 team last season, so they'll certainly be on upset alert but N Illinois is 13-4 as an AD under HC Hammock including an outright upset over Boston College in Week 1. We don't call for the upset in this one, we do think the Huskies will keep this one within the line.

Vanderbilt by 5 over UNLV - Only previous meeting came back in 2019 when UNLV (+15) went to Vandy and led 24-10 HT and pulled the upset 34-10. UNLV last hosted a Power 5 team back in '21 and they lost to Iowa St 48-3 (-359 yds). UNLV is off a trip to Michigan where they lost 35-7 (21-0 HT) while Vandy is on the road for a 2nd straight game after losing to Wake Forest LW. UNLV was 4-2 SU at home last season, and do have a solid team led by QB Brumfield and new HC Odom. Vandy QB Swann is hitting 61% with an 8-3 ratio TY and UNLV did allow 313 pass yds to Mich last week. On paper these teams seem fairly close, but Vandy was a road favorite LY at Hawaii (-9) and won 63-10 so we'll take Vandy, who is looking to get to 3-1 on the season, to survive a close game in the desert.

UAB by 3 over Louisiana - Louisiana won here 24-20 (-3) in the last matchup back in 2020 as both teams failed to reach 300 yards of total offense. Louisiana is 1-1 after a 38-31 (-6) loss at ODU last week. The Cajuns had a 458-392 edge, but were stopped on downs at the ODU 7 with :26 left. QB Ben Woolridge has thrown for 508 (57.4%) with a 5-1 ratio. UAB also enters 1-1 off a 49-35 (+7) loss at GA Southern. The Blazers offense has been impressive through 2 weeks as they are averaging 35 ppg and QB Jacob Zeno is hitting 84.5% of his passes (676 yds) with a 5-1 ratio. UAB did allow 344 pass yds last week after a strong performance against an FCS foe in Week 1. New UAB HC Trent Diller has his offense in a good rhythm and we expect their young defense to improve week-to-week, so we'll take the home team by a FG in this one.

MISSISSIPPI by 15 over Georgia Tech - UM was on the winning side of a misleading final last week when they beat Tulane 37-20 (-8). The Rebels trailed 17-13 at half and only led 27-20 late 4Q but got a fg and defensive td in the last 1:53. Ole Miss jumped on GT quickly LY and won 42-0 (-17). It seems like GT has turned the corner on offense. Last week GT put up their most yards (578) since switching from the triple option, beating SC St 48-13 (-44). GT also put up 34 points and 488 yards vs Louisville in the opener. QB Haynes King is completing 66% and has a 7-1 ratio. Ole Miss is allowing just 47% passing but faced an FCS team and Tulane's backup QB making his first start last week. This is a huge look-ahead spot for Ole Miss with Bama on deck and GT's offense seems to be vastly improved from last year. GT is 5-1 as an AD under HC Key. The Jackets won't pull the upset but they could keep it close for a half and score enough to stay within the opening line.

Pittsburgh by 3 over WEST VIRGINIA - 106th meeting of the Backyard Brawl! First mtg here since '11. LY's meeting saw WVU up 31-24 4Q but Pitt got 2 td's with under 4 min left 4Q incl the GW pick-6 with 2:58 left. Pitt is off a home loss to Cincy where they were -109 yards and allowed 216 rush yds (5.1). Pitt QB Jurkovec is hitting just 49% and the offense was held to 262 yds vs Cincy. WVU got their 1st win of the season LW over FCS Duquesne 56-17 where they put up 619 yds. WVU is led by QB Greene (58%, 4-0 ratio, 104 rush) and RB Donaldson (137, 4.4) and WVU has one of the top OLines in the FBS and will be tested vs a Pitt pass rush that has 6 sks (13.6%). Both teams have their conf openers on deck but neither team will be overlooking this rivalry game. Narduzzi has a remarkable record of 14-3 as an AF here and we see Pitt rebounding with a close win.

KENTUCKY by 21 over Akron - KY has won 15 straight vs MAC teams (11-3-1 ATS). The only prior meeting was in 2010 when KY won 47-10 (-24). The 'Cats had a poor effort last week, only beating Eastern KY 28-17 (-35) and actually trailed 10-7 3Q. Akron was on the fortunate side last week, beating Morgan St 24-21, returning a fumble for a td as the Bears were trying to run the clock out. Akron only put up 270 yards and QB Undercuffer threw 3 int's. KY beat Ball St 44-14 in the opener, getting a late td to cover but HC Stoops was regretful for the additional score. KY has their SEC opener on deck. We don't think they will have B2B flat spots but are still unlikely to run the score up on the Zips.

Syracuse by 6 over PURDUE - Purdue faces their 2nd straight ACC foe in a rematch of LY's 32-29 (-1) Syracuse win. Purdue led VTech 17-0 2Q but needed a 4Q td to win 24-17 (+1). They did have a 427-286 yd edge. Syracuse easily came through as a 3★ LPS last week, beating WMich 48-7 (-24). The Orange had a 363-182 yd edge and won 45-7. QB Shrader has a 5-1 ratio and is facing a

Purdue D that has allowed 323 pass ypg in their first two. Purdue did have a 485-306 yd edge in this game last year, but the addition of DC Rocky Long to run Cuse's 3-3-5 Defense gives us confidence the Orange perform better on defense. Cuse has the experience edge with 14 starters back and we think they go on the road and pick up a close win.

CLEMSON by 31 over Florida Atlantic - Clem won the only prior meeting back in 2006 54-6. All the talk in the first two weeks is how mistake prone Clemson has been. While they did lose to Duke 28-7, they finished with a 422-374 yd edge and gave away two fumbles inside the Duke 10. Last week they were tied 14-14 1Q with Charleston Southern but finished with a 679-73 yd edge, won 66-17 (-50) and in the 2H alone they had 414-31 yd edge. That looked more like the Clemson we expected this season. FAU was upset 17-10 (-3) at home vs Ohio where they put up just 185 yards and were held to 5 rush yards. HC Herman has been excellent as an underdog in his career and Clemson does have FSU on deck but we doubt Dabo wants to let go of the momentum they built last week and will want a strong effort here. The Owls do have 18 starters back and have covered at Purdue and Florida the last two years so they won't be intimidated so we are only giving the Tigers a small lean.

TEXAS by 24 over Wyoming - 6th meeting. Last time they met was in 2012 when Texas (-31) hosted Wyoming and won 37-17 but failed to cover. Texas is off an emotional win at Bama last week where QB Ewers threw for 349 yds and 3 td's & Tex's OLine is one of best in the nation and have allowed just 2 sks on 74 pass att. WY is also off to a 2-0 start and beat Portland St LW after upsetting Texas Tech in Week 1. WY typically relies on their run game & defense. So far this ssn they are running for 171 ypg (4.1) and are all g just 92 rush ypg (2.5) plus have 7 sks through 2 gms. Wyoming is 6-3 ATS as a DD dog since 2019 and Texas is off a big win and open Big 12 play next week. While Texas has no issues winning, we expect WY to cover.

OREGON by 42 over Hawaii - 8th meeting. Oregon has won 4 of the 7 mtgs but UH has actually won the last 3 mtgs. The last mtg came back 1994 when UH won 36-16. UO is off a 38-30 road win at Tex Tech where they got a late pick-6 for the cover (-6). UH got their first win of the ssn LW at home vs Albany 31-20 and overall have held 2 of their 3 foes to under 300 yds. UH has had some success throwing the ball (324 ypg) but the OL has allowed 14 sks (10.9%) and the run gm has put up 35 yds in 2 gms vs FBS foes. While Oregon has a marquee meeting with Colorado on deck & UH is on a 5-2 ATS run as an AD, the Ducks proved they could put up points even with the backups in 2 weeks ago and we the same thing happening here & call for Oregon by 6 td's.

TCU by 9 over HOUSTON - UH leads series 13-12 but TCU has won the last 5 meetings, but their last meeting was back in 2007 in the Texas Bowl, which TCU won 20-13. UH is off to a rocky start this season, as they were -83 yds in the opener but won by 3 pts (+3 TO's) and last week all'd 470 yds to Rice & lost in 2OT 45-43. TCU rebounded off their opening loss to CU and beat Nicholls 41-6. QB Morris is hitting 69% (4-2 ratio) and RB Bailey (231, 7.0) lead the TCU offense against a subpar UH defense. UH QB Smith is hitting 61% (4-1 ratio) and faces a pass D that all'd 510 in the opener, but TCU's run defense is all g 71 ypg (1.9) and has 7 sks in 2 gms. TCU is 3-1-1 ATS as an AF under Dykes while UH is just 1-5 ATS as a HD under Holgerson and we'll take TCU to get the win here by over a td.

COLORADO by 16 over Colorado St - 92nd meeting of the Rocky Mountain Showdown. CU has won 5 straight in the series (4-0-1 ATS). Last met in 2019 and CU won 52-31 despite CSU being +30 yds & +4 FD's (CSU was TO's). CU is off to a 2-0 start after their 36-14 home win last week vs Nebraska where QB Sanders threw for 393 yds & 2 td's. CSU is off an early bye week that might have been much-needed after losing 50-24 vs Wash St in the opener where they allowed 556 yds incl 466 passing. CU is having trouble rushing (57, 1.7) and have allowed 12 sks (13.2%). CU is off two emotional wins, and have Oregon and USC coming up the next 2 weeks. CSU is off a bye & this is an in-state rivalry so we feel like while the Buffs will win, the Rams will be able to cover the spread.

Fresno St by 3 over ARIZONA ST - 5th meeting. Last met in the 2018 Las Vegas Bowl where Fresno picked up their first win over Ariz St with a 31-20 victory. Ariz St is off to a 1-1 start after LW's loss to Okla St 27-15 where they were held to 277 yds & even the week before were held to 371 vs Southern Utah. Fresno did need 2OT to get past Eastern Wash last week, but that was a sandwich game in between two P5 road gms. Fresno QB Keene (65%, 6-2) has played well while Ariz St QB Rashada is hitting 56% and Fresno has the coaching edge here with Tedford (16th year as HC) vs Dillingham (1st year) Fresno is 6-2 ATS vs Pac-12 since '18 and have wins over Wash St and UCLA the last 2 years. Fresno already went on the road once TY to a P5 program and won at Purdue & we see them doing that again here.

Kansas by 24 NEVADA - First meeting. Kansas last played a MW foe in 2003 at Wyoming, while Nevada last faced a B12 foe back in '21, losing to Kansas St. Nev is off to an 0-2 start this season and are off a 33-6 home loss to FCS Idaho where they were outgained 463-266, while KU is off a marquee home win over Illinois last Friday that saw the return of QB Daniels who threw for 277 and 2 td's. Nevada has struggled vs the pass this season, all g 453 to USC and 313 to Idaho (73% completion % all'd), plus their run D all'd 215 (10.8 vs USC) and now face a KU run gm led by RB Neal (214, 9.3) that has put up 245 yds (6.5) and 262 yds (6.0) in their F2 gms. KU's defense also seems to be improved early on, all g just 217 yds & 341 their F2 gms. While we think KU rolls by over 3 td's, this is their first time as an AF since 2009 and dating back to 1978 have NEVER been an AF of 20+ points. KU also has their B12 opener on deck vs BYU and the current Vegas line is right around 4 td's, so we'll lean slightly with Nevada.

ARIZONA by 11 over Utah - AZ has won the last 13 meetings. They last met in '17 when the 'Cats were -23 & won 63-16. The 'Cats held a 431-307 yd edge at Miss St last week, falling from down 21-7 3Q but couldn't overcome QB de Laura's 4 int's. UTEP was tied 7-7 at half last week vs NW, was only outgained 391-319 and had an 18-17 FD edge but also had 3 TO's and lost 38-7. Arizona has their PAC-12 opener on deck. The 'Cats have the edge on offense but we give the defensive edge to UTEP and their veteran team could keep this within 2 td's.

4★ DENVER over Washington - Rematch of SB XXII ('87 ssn), a contest that saw the Redskins pick up an easy 42-10 victory. The Commanders picked up a 4 point victory LW at home against the Cardinals despite a trio of costly TO's (QB Howell 19-31-202-1-1, sacked 6 times!). The Broncos are at home for a 2nd straight week following a 1 pt loss against the Raiders in the debut of HC Sean Payton (QB Wilson 27-34-177-2-0). The home team in this series has won 5 straight (4-1 ATS) including a 17-10 (-3') win by the Broncos in "Mile High" where WAS had 21-17 FD and 342-273 yd edges. With the Commanders struggling in each of their past 3 road openers (SU & ATS) with a 15 pt avg defeat, we'll call for the Broncos to even their record at 1-1 in this one.

FORECAST: DENVER by 12

3★ CINCINNATI over Baltimore - After an easy 16 pt home victory against the Texans where we cashed a Power Sweep 4★ winner on BAL, the Ravens head to Cincy to take on a Bengals team that was shockingly held to just 6 FD's and 142 total yards in a 24-3 defeat (QB Burrow 14-31-82-0-0) at Cleveland. The Bengals have picked up victories in 4 of the past 5 against the Ravens including a 24-17 (-8') win in LY's WC Rnd with BAL being without the services of Lamar Jackson (BAL 364-234 yd edge, Bengals 98 yd FR TD). With the Ravens struggling inside of the AFC North having failed to cover 9 of their L/12 and an angry Bengals squad going 5-0 ATS as home chalk, CIN gets the win inside of "The Jungle" in this one (BAL RB Dobbins OFY, TE Andrews ? after missing Wk 1).

FORECAST: CINCINNATI by 10

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ ATLANTA over Green Bay - The Packers' offense looked much better than expected a week ago with Jordan Love (15-27-245-3-0) taking over under center for the departed Aaron Rodgers. They now head on the road for a 2nd straight week to take on a Falcons squad that forced 3 CAR TO's in a 24-10 victory (ATL's 1st Wk 1 win s/'17, CAR 281-221 yd edge). After winning 3 straight from '16-'17 (incl playoffs), the Falcons have dropped 2 straight to the Packers including a '20 trip to Lambeau where GB (-6') finished with a 403-327 yd edge in the 30-16 victory. Despite that, GB has failed to cover 7 of their L/9 as away chalk coming in and the Falcons were 3-0-1 ATS getting points at home a year ago. We'll go ahead and give the Falcons the edge in this one.

FORECAST: ATLANTA by 6

OTHER PLAYS

Minnesota at PHILADELPHIA - Thursday - The Vikings head into Philly following a surprise home loss to the Bucs (+4) who took advantage of 3 TO's by MIN (Vikings 369-242 yd edge). PHI meanwhile jumped out to a 16-0 lead before needing to hold on late in a 5 pt road win in Foxboro (NE 24-17 FD & 382-251 yd edges). These 2 also met in Wk 2 a year ago with the Eagles picking up a 24-7 victory (-2) on MNF with a 486-264 yd edge. While the Eagles are on an outstanding 10-3 ATS run as home chalk coming in, they have struggled overall ATS with just 4 covers in the past 11 contests dating back to LY. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

LA Chargers by 6 over TENNESSEE - Following a close 16-15 defeat in the Superdome where the Saints held them to just 285 yards, the Titans return to Nashville having failed to cover 6 of their past 7 home openers. That Chargers meanwhile head East after a 36-34 home loss to the Dolphins (MIA 536-433 yd edge). These 2 met a year ago with the Chargers (-3) connecting on a GW 43-yd FG with :04 left (LAC 23-17 FD & 365-284 yd edges). Although the Titans have gone a solid 9-4 ATS as a NDIV HD, we're concerned about their weak OL (all'd 49 sks LY) taking on a Chargers front-7 that features some of the elite pass rushers in the NFL (LAC 4-1-2 ATS in road openers).

Houston by 4 over Indianapolis - A pair of 0-1 DIV squads square off in this one as the Colts (10 pt loss LW at home vs JAX, rookie QB Richardson inq'd late after 263 tll yds, 2 TD, 1 int) head to HOU to take on a Texans team that struggled LW in BAL with rookie QB Stroud hitting 28-44-242-0-0 in a 16 pt defeat (4★ Newsletter Winner on the Ravens!). After losing 7 of 8 matchups, the Texans picked up a tie at home LY against the Colts and a victory at IND in the ssn finale (GW 28-yd TD pass w/:50 left). While HOU has gone just 2-8 ATS when listed as home chalk, they are a solid 10-4 ATS vs AFC South members. With the Colts failing to cover 12 of their L/15 inside of the DIV, we'll give the home squad a small lean in what should be a battle of young QB's (Richardson expected back as of presstime).

DETROIT by 8 over Seattle - Following a surprising Thur night victory in Arrowhead against the Chiefs where they finished with 368-316 yard edges and overcame a 4Q deficit, the Lions return to Ford Field having covered 4 of the past 5 as a HF. The Seahawks meanwhile saw a shorthanded Rams squad (WR Kupp out) outscore them 23-0 in the 2H of an eventual 30-13 (+5) victory (LAR 27-13 FD & 426-180 yd edges). The Seahawks have won 5 consecutive matchups (4-1 ATS) including a pair of shootout victories the past 2 years (48-45 in '22, 51-29 in '21). They are however on just a 1-8 overall ATS run. With the Lions covering 10 of their L/11 overall and the Seahawks playing at 10am PST, a potential slow start by the visitor has us leaning with DET in this one.

TAMPA BAY by 5 over Chicago - The Bucs return home following a surprising 3 pt road upset of the Vikings where QB Mayfield went 21-34-173-2-0 in his TB debut (MIN 369-242 yd edge, -3 TO's). The Bears meanwhile continue to be "owned" by the Packers despite the departure of Aaron Rodgers as Jordan Love threw for 245 yards and 3 TD's in a 38-20 victory. The home team has won 5 in a row SU/ATS in the series with a 24 pt avg MOV including a 38-3 (-12) win by the Bucs in '21 where Tom Brady threw 4 TD's. While TB is on just a 3-12-1 ATS run coming in, the Bears have failed to cover 6 of their past 8 road openers and didn't live up to the hype a week ago.

BUFFALO by 4 over Las Vegas - The Bills are back at home following a MNF trip to take on the Jets. They now face off against a Raiders squad that's already taking their 2nd road trip of the season after getting a 1 point comeback upset victory in "Mile High" where QB Garoppolo threw for 200 yards and 2 TD's in his "Silver & Black" debut. The Bills have come out victorious in each of the past 2 matchups including a 30-23 (-3) win in '20 (QB Allen 287 tll yds & 3 TD). While they are also 10-5 ATS as a NDIV HF, a short week to prepare along with the Raiders covering 12 of their past 17 as an AD as us calling for the visitor to stay within the line.

JACKSONVILLE by 3 over Kansas City - Rematch of LY's DIV Rnd contest that saw the Chiefs (-9) and a banged-up Patrick Mahomes escape Arrowhead with a 27-20 victory (7th straight win in the series, 5-2 ATS). The Chiefs head into JAX with extra rest following a 21-20 home defeat against the Lions last Thur where All-Pro TE Travis Kelce missed with injury (KC had 12 different players targeted for a pass in the game!). The Jags meanwhile picked up a 10 pt win LW in IND thanks to a pair of TD's in the final 5:17 of the 4Q (JAX 342-280 yd edge). KC has gone a solid 7-3 ATS in road openers while there's a good chance that Kelce will return to the field. However, the Jaguars' 5-0 ATS mark as a HD has us calling for a mild upset and some revenge for them here.

NY Giants by 6 over ARIZONA - The Giants head into the desert following an embarrassing home effort against rival DAL where they were held to just 171 yards in a 40-0 defeat (QB Jones 15-28-104-0-2). The Cardinals meanwhile nearly pulled the upset of the Commanders a week ago despite just 13 FD's and 210 total yards (QB Dobbs 21-30-132-0-0). The Cardinals have

rattled off 4 consecutive victories SU and ATS against the Giants including a 26-7 (-2) road win in '20 where they had substantial FD (22-10) and yardage (390-159) edges. While the Giants are away chalk for the first time in 3 years, backing this rebuilding Cardinals squad is something we're staying away from at this moment (NYG on a 6-2 overall ATS run).

San Francisco by 9 over LA RAMS - The 49ers are back on the road for a 2nd straight week following a 30-7 win in PIT where RB McCaffrey (22-152, 1 TD) and WR Aiyuk (8-129, 2 TD) had huge efforts. The Rams also surprisingly picked up a win a week ago in upset fashion with 27-13 FD and 426-180 yard edges in a 30-13 victory. The 49ers have won 8 of their past 9 meetings (6-3 ATS) against the Rams with the only defeat coming in the '21 NFC Championship (LA overcame a 17-7 deficit in the 4Q!). The Rams were 7-0 SU/ATS run in home openers with a 17 pt avg MOV, that ended a ssn ago with the Bills picking up the easy 31-10 (-2) win (LAR outgained 413-243).
