## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ TENNESSEE over Utsa** - Tenn is 8-0 SU/6-2 ATS in non-conf games under Heupel. The Vols must once again bounce back after losing to Florida. They did finish with a 387-349 yd edge. UTSA is also off an upset when they didn't have QB Harris and lost to Army 37-29 (-8). Backup QB Marburger did throw for 239 and 3 td's but UTSA was outgained 442-360. Last year the Vols bounced back after their losses to UGA and SC with wins by 42 and 56 and they were 4-1 ATS off a Loss in '21. QB Harris may get rested again with their AAC opener on deck. The Vols have a revenge game vs SC on deck but won't hold back in a blowout. We've been on the right side of all 3 of Tenn's games and we expect the Vols to easily clear the early line which is under 3 td's!

**FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 31**

**3★ UTAH over UCLA** - Following a 24 pt home win against Weber St where they all'd kуст 5 FD's and 127 yds, Utah is back in SLC for a 2nd consec week to take on a UCLA squad that also sits at 3-0 on the yr after a 52 pt home win over their own FCS foe in NC Central (614-232 yd edge). The HT in this series is on a 4-1 SU/ATS run including UCLA's 42-32 (+3) win a ssn ago where they were just 1 of 2 squads to rush for 200+ yards against Utah in '22. With revenge on their mind in this one as well as the potential return of both QB Rising at TE Kuithe (both missed 1st 3), we expect Utah to record their 16th straight home win (26 of L/27) here (Utah 6-2 ATS as a HF) with UCLA true Fr QB Dante Moore (62%, 5-1 ratio) making his 1st career road start.

**FORECAST: UTAH by 16**

**3★ SOUTH CAROLINA over Mississippi St** - These two haven't met since '16 when MSU won 27-14 (-7) but SC has won the previous 6 mtgs. SC jumped out to a 14-3 lead at half vs UGA and easily covered as 27 pt underdogs, losing by 24-14. MSU barely hung on to beat AZ in OT 2 weeks ago (outg'd 431-307) then were smoked by LSU 41-14 (+9) and outgained 530-201. QB Rogers has a 5-0 ratio but has been held to 162 and 107 passing the L2W as MSU has tried to force their new identity away from the Air Raid. MSU allowed 340 and 367 passing vs AZ and LSU and QB Rattler is hitting 71% while SC is throwing for 357 ypg. SC is 6-2 as a HF and 6-2 ATS vs the SEC West and think SC wins by DD's.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Arkansas (+) over LSU** - This series has been defensive slugfests the L2Y with LSU winning 13-10 (-3) LY while Ark won 16-13 (-3) LTH in '21. Ark is 5-2-1 ATS in Baton Rouge. LSU dominated Miss St last week 41-14 (-9). Jayden Daniels is hitting 74% with an 8-1 ratio and is LSU's leading rusher again. Ark blew 14 and 10 point leads last week vs BYU. They finished with a 424-281 yd edge and had an 88 yd PR td but lost 38-31 (-8). The Hogs have yet to allow 300 yards in a game and have 12 sacks and are allowing 1.7 ypc. LSU took advantage of a team that is completely changing their identity last week while Ark was unlucky in a loss. The value is on the underdog Hogs with Pittman coming in 13-6-1 as a dog.

**FORECAST: LSU by 10**

**2★ SOUTH ALABAMA over Central Michigan** - Only prior meeting was LY when SAla (+6) led 31-10 at the half and won outright 38-24. SAla is off a big upset win at Okla St where they won 33-7 (+187 yds, +2 TO's) while CMich has 24 pt losses to Mich St and Notre Dame and barely beat New Hampshire 2 wks ago (45-42, -100 yds). CMich's defense has all'd 507 ypg this season incl 371 pass ypg all'd. Their offense has only gained 219 & 268 vs 2 FBS foes, while SAla's offense is led by QB Bradley (72%) and the Jags have gained 248 rush (7.1) and 243 rush (5.2) the L/2 gms. SAla's defense is also a strong point & they are holding tms to 99 rush ypg (3.2). While SAla has JMU on deck, the Jags appear to have their swagger back & will take care of business by 3 td's.

## OTHER GAMES

### THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 21st

**COASTAL CAROLINA vs Georgia St** - Each team has won 3 times, but the home team is on a 0-5-1 ATS run. LY they met on a Thurs night and Coastal (-2) led by 10 pts HT and won 41-24 (+231 yds, +3 TO's). CC has won 2 straight after losing their opener, while GSt is off to a 3-0 start. GSt is moving the ball well on the ground (194, 4.8) while CC is allowing 174 (4.7) on the ground, while GSt's run D is all'g just 83 ypg (2.6). CC's offense is avg'g just 372 ypg vs FBS foes and all'd 7 sks the F/2 gms. CC is just 1-6 ATS as a HF against SBC foes since '21 while GSt is on a 7-2 ATS as an SBC AD. ### FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 22nd

**Wisconsin by 7 over PURDUE** - Wisconsin has won 16 straight in the series, but are just 3-13 ATS in those meetings. The Badgers did cover LTH in 2021 with a 30-13 (-3) shellacking when the held the Boilers to just 206 total yds. Wisconsin also won last year's matchup 35-24 (-1.5), despite being outgained 431-381. WISC (2-1, 1-2 ATS) forced 6 TO's in their 35-14 (-20) home win over GA Southern, but didn't pull away until the 4Q. Purdue fell to 1-2 SU/ATS with their 35-20 (-2) home loss to Syracuse and the Boilermakers are now allowing 30 ppg and 398 ypg. The Badgers have a bye on deck, but have yet to put together a full game and are already 0-1 as an AF, so we'll lean slightly with the Boilers at home in this one.

**NC State by 14 over VIRGINIA** - NCSt OC Robert Anae and QB Brennan Armstrong face their former team. The Wolfpack are off an easy 45-7 win over VMI. Their 45-24 loss vs Notre Dame two weeks ago was a little misleading as they only trailed by 7 entering the 4Q. UVA has shown some punch on offense under true frosh QB Colandrea but the defense allowed 36 points 2 wks ago vs JMU then after leading MD 14-0 last week they were outscored 42-0 the rest of the way. Colandrea threw 3 int's last week and faces his toughest test against a solid NCSt D. NCSt has won & covered 4 of the last 5 meetings but they haven't met since '20. We think Armstrong has a big game vs his former team and NCSt has a big defensive edge so our lean is with the 'Pack.

**Boise St by 3 over SAN DIEGO ST** - Each team has won 4 times as MW foes, but Boise St is just 2-6 ATS vs SDSU & the Aztecs have pulled 4 outright upsets incl the last time here in '21 where Boise (-3) led 16-3 late 2Q but were shut out from there & lost 27-16. Boise got their 1st win LW vs N.Dakota, but RB Holani DNP (CS) while SDSU dropped to 2-2 after losing to Oregon St. Neither team is playing up to their standard as Boise is all'g 549 ypg/37 ppg vs FBS foes while SDSU is all'g 437 ypg and their 2 wins were vs an Ohio tm w/o their star QB and only beat Idaho St by 8 pts. SDSU is only avg'g 93 ypg (2.8) & their OLine has all'd 11 sks L/3 gms & Boise had 6 sks last week. We like Boise to win this MW matchup but think it will be a close game.

**Air Force by 6 over SAN JOSE ST** - As MW foes AF is 3-1 SU vs SJSt, but the Spartans have covered 3 of the 4 mtgs. Last met in '20 and SJSt (+7) held AF to 298 total yds in a 17-6 win. AF won their MW opener LW 39-21 vs USU, while SJSt only lost at Toledo by 4 pts. AF's DEF has been strong early in this season, all'g just 179 ypg/10 ppg and have all'd 133 total rush yds in 3 gms, while also collecting 11 sks (15%). SJSt has all'd 432 ypg/40 ppg against FBS foes, and all'd 229 rush (6.4) LW. SJSt is 7-3 ATS since 2018 as a MW home dog & have faced the tougher sked, but the Falcons have looked dominant early on & we'll call for AF by under a TD.

### SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 23rd

**WAKE FOREST by 4 over Georgia Tech** - GT is 7-3 SU but only 4-6 ATS in this series. The Jackets are 5-1 as AD but WF is 18-10 as HF. WF barely survived a trip to ODU last week, outgained 277-127 in the 1H and down 24-7 3Q. The Deacons scored the last 20 points and won by a fg. GT is off a misleading final where they were within a td in the 4Q at Ole Miss last week but gave up 24 points

in the last 8 minutes and lost 48-23 (+17). Haynes King threw for 307 and now has a 9-1 ratio. GT is averaging 513 ypg including 310 pass ypg. WF allowed 314 pass yds in their only game vs a P5 (Vandy). WF had 10 sacks last week but GT's Oline has allowed just 3 this year. This should be a high scoring game and we lean with the underdog who is more battle tested.

**Miami, FI by 28 over TEMPLE** - 1st meeting since '05. Temple is hosting a Power 5 school for the 2nd consecutive year as they took Rutgers to the wire last year in a 16-14 (+18) loss. Miami hasn't traveled to play a non-Power 5 opponent since 2018. The Hurricanes are off an easy 48-7 (-51) win over FCS foe Bethune-Cookman in which they outgained BC 589-165 and only allowed a garbage-time td with 1:19 left. Miami is off to their first 3-0 start since 2020. Temple (2-1, 1-2 ATS) blew out FCS foe Norfolk St 41-9 (-30) LW as they allowed just 240 total yards. The Hurricanes have a bye on deck, so their sole focus should be on the Owls here and they have too much firepower and we expect Miami to win by over 4 tds.

**SYRACUSE by 11 over Army** - First meeting since 1996. Army enters off an upset win, beating UTSA 37-29 (+8), and finished with a 442-360 yd edge but they did face the Roadrunners backup QB. Syracuse doesn't have much experience against the option but DC Rocky Long had great success against Air Force during his years at SDSU and New Mexico. Syracuse is 3-0 after beating Purdue 35-20 (-2) but they've got a huge game vs Clemson on deck. QB Shrader ran for 195 yds and 4 td's but he's battled injuries in the past so they may preserve him here. Syracuse has handled their non-Power-5 foes (12-2 ATS s/18) but with a big game on deck we lean with the dog.

**Texas Tech by 1 over WEST VIRGINIA** - TT has covered 8 of their 11 gms as Big 12 foes and have also won and covered each of the L/4 meetings. TT got their 1st win last week after losing to WY and Oregon the F/2 gms. WVU is off a big rivalry win vs Pitt, holding them to 211 yds, but QB Greene was banged up (leg inj) and his status is ? here. TT has put up 434 ypg/35 ppg this season and are actually +56 ypg and +17 FD's this season and WVU's defense did allow 478 yds/38 pts incl 332 pass yds vs Penn St in the opener & TT is avg'g 272 pass ypg. WVU does have a strong OL & run gm, but TT needs a win to avoid a 1-3 start and we'll side with them to win a close gm.

**MARSHALL by 1 over Virginia Tech** - VT has won 9 straight meetings but haven't met since '18. VT was without their starting QB and top WR last week when they lost 35-16 (+7) at Rutgers. QB Wells could be back to face his former team but backup QB Drones gives the Hokies dual threat ability (190 pass, 74 rush LW). Marshall is 2-0 and is fresh off a bye. VT is a rare ACC home dog vs a Sun Belt foe and they already beat ODU who has looked better than expected the last two weeks. If VT is healthy we think they could pull the upset.

**GEORGIA by 42 over Uab** - UGA has now had three straight slow starts this season. They've scored just 1 td in the 1Q of their 3 games and trailed SC 14-3 last week. We cashed a 3H LP Totals play on the under 54' as the Dawgs dominated the 2H and won 24-14 (-27). UAB is struggling under 1st yr HC Trent Duffer. The Blazers allowed 49 pts 2 wks ago at GA Strn and last week trailed 41-13 (-2) 4Q vs Louisiana before scoring 3 td's in the last 4:10. UGA is 0-3 ATS this year, and are 1-11 ATS as home favorites of -35 or more. We do think HC Smart will want UGA to have a faster start and UAB's poor performance has us going against the trends.

**MASSACHUSETTS by 4 over New Mexico** - First meeting. Lobos furthest trip east (2000+ miles) since a 38-27 loss at Rutgers in 2016. Minutemen are in rare role as favorite as they have only been favored twice since 2019 losing both outright incl a 35-22 to Rhode Island as a 1 pt HF in '21. UMass is off a heartbreaking 19-17 loss to EM as a 7 pt AD, allowing a game winning 50 yd GW td pass with 1:20 left. The Lobos are off a 27-17 loss as a 2' pt HF to instate rival New Mexico St. While they were only outgained 401-397, they were out FD's 26-15. UMass opened the season beating New Mexico St 41-30 as a 7 pt AD thanks to being +3 TO as they were outgained 458-389 but only out FD's 20-17. That has a leaning slightly with the Minutemen.

**LOUISVILLE by 18 over Boston College** - The home team is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in this series but BC has covered 6 of the L/9. BC pulled the upset over UL last year when QU Cunningham was inj'd, winning 34-33 (+13). The Eagles nearly pulled another Red Bandana Day upset LW, only losing to Florida St 31-29 (+25). QB Castellanos ran for 95 yds and threw for 305. UL is 3-0 after beating Indiana 21-14 (-10). They led 21-0 but didn't score in the 2H and needed a goaline stand to secure the victory. This is BC's road opener and Castellano's first road start. BC suffered road losses by 17, 30, 28, 10 & 44 last year while UL's last five home wins have come by 29 ppg so our lean is with the home team.

**INDIANA by 23 over Akron** - 1st meeting since 2010. Akron is 2-32 SU all-time vs Big 10 tms and 1-5 SU/ATS since '16. The Hoosiers meanwhile, are on 1-5 ATS run against non-Power 5 schools. Indiana is off a 21-14 (+10) loss, but has covered 3 straight to start the season. Akron is off 35-3 (-25) loss at Kentucky which moved them to 0-3 ATS this year and the Zips are averaging 16 ppg and just 239 ypg. Indiana is an improved team defensively and the offense has made some strides the last few weeks with Tayven Jackson at QB, so we'll side with the Hoosiers squad by 3 tds.

**CLEMSON by 3 over Florida St** - The last time Clemson was a home dog was in '16 when the Tigers were +2 and beat Louisville 42-36. Clemson has won the last 7 meetings and covered 5 straight vs FSU. LY they were up 34-14 going into 4Q. The talk of Clemson's run being over seems premature to us. Their week 1 loss to Duke was on the road and swung largely by TO's. QB Klubnik played a clean game last week, throwing for 3 td's and 0 int's in their 48-14 (-24) win over FAU. FSU barely hung on to beat BC, 31-29 (-25). FSU's pass D has given up 305 and 347 in 2 games vs P5's. The 'Noles were fortunate to not be down 17 at half in the opener vs LSU and pulled away late. Clemson has the edge on D, and is an angry home dog, ready to prove they are still the best in the ACC. Back in '18 won our Sept 5★ on Clemson when they easily beat GTech 48-21 (-16) and the Tigers are back on our radar this year!

**Duke by 14 over CONNECTICUT** - Duke enters 3-0 for the 2nd straight season and has a chance to be 4-0 for first time s/18. The Blue Devils continued their dominance of non-conference foes, beating Northwestern 38-14 (-17). Duke finished w/a 487-267 yd edge and didn't punt until the 4Q. Duke is 35-9 SU/33-11 ATS vs non-conf foes since 2013 but are in a rare spot with a huge game vs Notre Dame on deck. UConn is now 0-3 after losing to FIU 24-17 as 7 point home favorites and they actually trailed 24-3 at half. Duke is +158 ypg while UConn is -60 ypg. The Huskies did only lose to NCST by 10 in the opener and the largest of their last six losses is by just 21 points. Normally we would be all over Duke in non-conf play but they may be looking ahead to the Irish.

**North Carolina by 3 over PITTSBURGH** - The home team in this series is 4-0 ATS and the Tar Heels are 7-3 SU/6-3 ATS. The Tar Heels enter 3-0 after beating Minnesota 31-13 (-7). Pitt's offense has been abysmal in their last two games, putting up just 262 yds vs Cincy and 211 last week at WV in their 17-6 (+2) loss. QB Jurkovec has completed just 35% in their two losses and threw 3 int's last week but QB Maye has a 10-10 ratio in his L/7 gms. NC's defense allowed 494 yds two weeks ago vs App St. This is their first true road game and the Heels are 1-7-1 as an AF since '20. We have to believe Pitt will have a better performance on offense and their D can still keep them in games so we only have NC by a fg.

**KANSAS by 13 over BYU** - Only prior meeting came in the 1992 Aloha Bowl, where KU won 23-20. This is BYU's first Big 12 game and first conference game since 2010. BYU is off to a 3-0 start, as they won LW at Ark despite being -143 yds. KU is 3-0 for the 2nd straight season and are avg'g 500 ypg/38 ppg, and their defense is actually playing well, giving up just 274 ypg and 21 ppg. BYU hasn't been anything special on offense (311 ypg) and are struggling to run the ball (78, 2.7). While BYU is on a 12-4 ATS run as an away dog, KU is on a 5-0 ATS run as a home favorite & we see the Jayhawks winning by just under 2 td's in front of their electric home crowd.

**MICHIGAN by 20 over Rutgers** - Teams have met every year since '14 and Michigan is 8-1 SU but just 4-5 ATS vs the Scarlet Knights. Michigan blew Rutgers out 52-17 (-26) last year, but LTH ('21) Rutgers outgained the Wolverines 352-275 but fell 20-13 (+20). Rutgers is off to their 3rd straight 3-0 (3-0 ATS) start after their 35-16 (-7) win over VA Tech. The Knights were actually outgained, but ran for 256 yds and is averaging 211 (4.9) rush ypg. Michigan is also 3-0 (0-3 ATS) and coming off a 31-6 (-40) win over Bowling Green. The Wolverines are now allowing just 5 ppg and 223 ypg. Michigan's offense has yet to fire on all cylinders against weak non-conference foes and we think Rutgers' solid Big10 defense can help keep this one within the line.

**Oklahoma by 17 over CINCINNATI** - Only have met twice before in 2008 and 2010 with OU winning 52-26 at home, but won just 31-29 at Cincy. This is Cincy's first game as a Big 12 team and after a 2-0 start, they lost at home LW for just the 2nd time in their L33 home gms despite being +180 yds (SOD & missed FG after long drives). QB Jones is hitting 66% (7-3 ratio) and RB Kiner is playing well (289, 6.1). However, OU will be their toughest test yet as they come in here 3-0 and are avg'g 534 ypg/56 ppg led by QB Gabriel (82%, 11-1) and the DEF is holding tms to just 289 ypg and have all'd just 27 total pts in 3 gms. OU's run D is all'g just 80 ypg (2.3). Nippert is a tough place to play, but this is a noon gm & OU is by far Cincy's toughest test yet so we like the Sooners by over 2 td's.

**Georgia Southern by 8 over BALL ST** - Only prior meeting was LY at GS where the Eagles (-9) led just 13-10 and got a late 4Q td to get the covering, winning 34-23. GS is off a loss to Wisconsin where they put up 455 yds but QB Brin had a 1-5 ratio, and 2 weeks ago gained 462 yds & scored 49 pts vs UAB. Ball St won vs Indiana St last week but faced UK & UGA the F/2 wks and lost by a comb'd score of 89-17 and gained under 300 yds in each gm, but did out FD UK 18-17. Ball St is just 4-11 ATS as a home dog under HC Neu, while this is the 1st time GStmn is an AF since '20, but HC Helton is 11-7 ATS as an AF. We'll take the higher-powered offense to win by over a td.

**Rice by 6 over USF** - 1st meeting and it's the AAC debut for Rice as they make the move from CUSA. Rice is 1-4 SU (2-3 ATS) conference road openers since '18. USF on the otherhand has lost their last 4 conf home openers (1-3 ATS). The Bull played toe-to-toe with Bama for a half LW as it waqs tied 3-3 at HT. They eventually fell 17-3 (+34), but held the Tide to just 310 yds. Rice beat FCS for TX Southern 59-7 (-35) and is 3-0 ATS to start the year. The Owls featured a balanced attack that saw them rush for 231 (4.5) and throw. The Owls have some confidence after 2 straight wins and they have actually covered their last 4 games played Florida, so we'll side with the road team here.

**TOLEDO by 28 over Western Michigan** - This is the MAC opener for both teams. In last year's regular season finale Toledo with the MAC Title game on deck only played their banged up starting QB for 1Q before resting him and lost 20-14 as an 8 pt AF thanks in part to the backup throwing a pick 6 as UT finished with a 334-188 yd edge with an 18-8 FD edge (allowed a 63 yd td run). LTH WM (-1) led 15-13 at HT but were outscored 21-0 in 2H. Broncos are off 2 straight SU & ATS losses as a dog of 24+.. Toledo has big edges on both Offense (#49-#127) & Defense (#48-#125) and also have the coaching edge (9th yr vs 1st yr). This is WM's third straight road game. We look for the defending MAC Champs to open the season with a statement win here.

**IOWA ST by 1 over Oklahoma St** - This has been a close matchup of late as the L/8 mtgs have been decided by 7 pts or less. Okla St is on a 9-2 SU/7-3-1 ATS run in the series. LY Okla St (+1) won 20-14 despite being -89 yds (+3 TO's). Okla St is off a 33-7 loss vs SAla where they gained just 208 yds, while ISU is off a 10-7 loss at Ohio where we won our 4.5★ Totals GOM on the Under 42! The 'Pokes haven't looked great on offense (256 ypg vs FBS foes) and still don't appear to have a clear-cut QB, Iowa St has struggled to move the ball too, as QB Becht has just a 4-3 ratio and ISU is avg'g just 270 ypg but their D is all'g just 254 ypg, while Okla St has 10 sks in 3 games (12.2%). Both defenses will show out here and we'll take the home team to win what we think will be a defensive slugfest.

**Minnesota by 17 over NORTHWESTERN** - The Gophers have won and covered 3 straight in the series, including 2 straight in Evanston. Minnesota has won the last 2 by a combined score of 72-17, including a 41-14 (-7) win LTH here in 2021. The Gophers are 2-1 (0-3 ATS) after their 31-13 (+7) loss at N Carolina in which they were outgained 519-303. Northwestern (1-2 SU/ATS) lost 38-14 (+17) at Duke LW and are averaging just 286 ypg this season. The visitor is on a 3-1 ATS run in the series and we think that trend continues here, so we'll take the Gophers to control the action and move to 2-0 in Big10 play.

**ILLINOIS by 10 over Florida Atlantic** - 1st meeting. FAU is 0-4 SU vs Big10 foes, but is 3-1 ATS including a 28-26 (+16) loss at Purdue last season. FAU is 1-2 (0-3 ATS) after their 48-14 (+24) loss at Clemson and the Owls are averaging just 239 ypg vs FBS foes. The Illini fell 30-13 (-14) to Penn St to fall to 1-2 (0-3 ATS). QB Luke Altmyer threw 4 ints and was replaced by Ball St transfer John Paddock who hit 10-16 for 129 yds and a td and it wouldn't be a surprise to see both QB's in this one. The Illini are just 3-6 ATS vs non-conf opponents under Bielema (0-2 TY) and FAU HC Tom Herman is 17-5 ATS as an underdog, so we like the Owls to keep this one within a line that opened around 2 tds.

**Southern Miss by 13 over ARKANSAS ST** - 13th mtg, but just 2nd as SBC foes. LY SMiss (-4) trailed 19-7 into the 4Q but got 2 td's in final 10 min to win 20-19. Ark St is avg'g just 219 ypg vs FBS foes and are -5 TO's on the season, plus are dealing with an inj to QB ShROUT & the bkps comb'd to go 11-23 for 140 yds LW. SMiss is off to a 1-2 start but have talented RB Gore and QB Wiles could be the guy they are looking for. While this is a lot of points to lay on the road, SMiss was 2-0 ATS as an AF last season, while Ark St is on a 2-6 ATS run as a home dog.

**James Madison by 2 over UTAH ST** - First meeting. JMU is off to a 3-0 start after a 16-14 win in Troy last week, while USU lost at AF 39-21 where they got down 29-0 and QB Legas was pulled for true frosh bkw Hillstead, who led USU on 3 td drives. JMU is all'g just 23 rush ypg (0.8) incl all'g -12 rush yds LW! However their pass D has all'd 377 and 333 in B2B gms, but the pass rush does have 13 sks. JMU is quickly becoming one of the top G5 tms in the FBS and while this is their 3rd straight road game & they have SAla on deck, they won the previous 2 & we see them getting a close win.

**Arizona by 3 over STANFORD** - The Cardinal moved to 1-2 on the year following a surprising 7 pt home loss (outgained 448-387) to SU HC Taylor's former team (30-8 record at Sac St from '19-'22), they now face off against an Arizona squad for the first time since 2019. The Wildcats picked up a 21 pt win LW at home against UTEP with QB De Laura throwing for 285 yds and 3 TD's. Arizona has struggled in this series with 6 consec losses (1-5 ATS, 22 pt avg defeat) while they haven't been a favorite against the Cardinal since way back in '09. In fact, this will be the Wildcats' first conf AF role since the early part of '18. While Stanford has gone just 2-7 ATS the past 2 years as a dog on "The Farm", we're cutting off our lean for Arizona at just a FG in this rare situation.

**Usc by 37 over ARIZONA ST** - USC's offense has looked unstoppable so far TY as they sit #2 in the FBS at 59.3 ppg (#5 w/581 ypg) with defending Heisman Winner QB Williams continuing to dominate (293 pass ypg, 78.6%, 12-0 ratio). USC heads to Tempe with extra rest following a bye wk to take on an ASU squad that dropped their 2nd straight home matchup LW against Fresno who with a shocking 8 TO's (24-15 FD & 350-230 yd in 29-0 defeat) and were down to their 4th string QB with true frosh Rashada sitting out and 2 backups were injured. LY ASU (+25) only trailed by 4 at HT in the eventual 42-25 loss (Trojans 485-331 yd edge). While the visitor has a matchup on deck against a potential unbeaten Colorado in Boulder, ASU has failed to cover 5 of their L/6 as a HD.

**OREGON by 28 over Colorado** - While the Colorado early season storyline has intrigued much of the nation following their 3-0 start that includes a comeback 20T home win over rival Colo St (CU 98-yd TD drive w/36 left, Rams 499-418 yd edge), they now head into Eugene for their first P12 matchup of the year against a Ducks squad that's #1 in the nation in scoring offense at 59.5 ppg (did score 81 vs FCS foe Port St) after a 45 pt home win LW against Hawaii where they had 26-15 FD and 560-201 yd edges. Since 2001, Oregon has won 9 of 10 SU & ATS against CU including a 49-10 (-31) victory LY in Boulder. With Colorado also going 2-7 ATS vs the P12 and 0-6 ATS as an AD a year ago, this should FINALLY be the week when their undefeated bubble bursts.

**WASHINGTON by 14 over California** - The Golden Bears have played much better than expected in their 2-1 start with wins over North Texas and Idaho (17-0 2H run after trailing by 3 at HT, Vandals 387-370 yd edge) along with a narrow home loss to Auburn back in Wk 2. The Huskies meanwhile have outscored their first 3 foes by 35 ppg including a 41-7 victory LW on the road against Mich St (QB Penix 473 pass yds & 4 TD). UW owns just a 11-9 SU (10-10 ATS) lead in this series including a 28-21 (-7) win LY in Berkeley. With the dog covering 4 straight (incl 2 upsets) and Cal going 13-3 ATS as an AD the previous 5 years, we're leaning with the visitor here.

**Oregon St by 1 over WASHINGTON ST** - It's fitting that the Beavers and Cougars face each other to begin P12 play as the 2 remaining teams without a home for next season. Both teams remain undefeated as OSU (475-326 yd edge in 17 pt win vs Sdst) heads to the Palouse after picking up their first series win in 9 tries (s/'14) LY in Corvallis (WSU 12 pt avg MOV in prior 8). The Cougars (43 pt win LW vs N Colorado, 718-366 yd edge) have gone 6-2 ATS as a HD the past 2 years including an outright upset of Wisconsin 2 weeks ago (+5). The Beavers meanwhile are just 2-7 ATS as away chalk dating back to the year that WSU began their 8-game winning streak.

**Ohio by 17 BOWLING GREEN** - While both have struggled on offense, Ohio has a big defensive edge (#40-#101) holding tms to 243 ypg/12 ppg. Those facts were demonstrated last week when Ohio only scored 10 but held Iowa St to just 7. Giving us a very easy 4.5★ Totals GOM winner (under 42.5). BG has some injury concerns as their starting QB, Indiana transfer Bazalek was injured in practice & DNP LW (CS), then backup QB Orth who started was knocked out in 2Q vs Michigan forcing them to play walk-on QB Timosciek. LB Hardamon was also carted off the field. Ohio is off a big win, but this is their MAC opener and we look for the Bobcats to take care of business.

**Maryland by 3 over MICHIGAN ST** - These teams have met 8 of the last 9 years and MSU is 6-2 SU (4-4 ATS) and has won all 4 meetings in East Lansing. Maryland did win 27-13 (-7.5) at home LY with a commanding 489-321 yard edge. The Terps are 3-0 (1-2 ATS) but have gotten off to slow starts the last 2 weeks as they've trailed by 14 in the 1H off both, but have rallied to outscore their foes 57-6 in the 2H. The Spartans allowed 713 yds to Washington last week in a 41-7 (+16) home loss in MSU's 1st game without HC Tucker. Maryland travels for the first time this year and the Terps are just 2-3 ATS as a B10 road fav under HC Locksley and Mich St is in game 2 under interim HC Harlon Barnett and that comfortability should allow them to keep this one close.

**Kentucky by 11 over VANDERBILT** - KY is out for legit revenge after they allowed Vandy to snap their 26 gm SEC losing streak last year. The 'Cats were -17' and led 21-17 but Vandy went 80/12 GW to w/32 left. Vandy returns home after losing B2B on the road including LW at UNLV 40-37 (-4). The 'Cats won 35-3 (-25) over Akron last week. RB Ray Davis has 236 (7.2) and faces his former team who allowed 288 rush to WF 2 wks ago. Vandy is on a 6-21 ATS run at home. The 'Cats last 3 wins at Vandy have been by 17, 24 and 23. KY does have Florida on deck but they have a huge edge on D and will have more fans in the stands but Vandy is getting nearly 2 td's here which and KY hasn't looked dominant on offense.

Mizzou is in a letdown spot after beating #15 Kansas St on The Thicker Kicker's 61 yd fg. Memphis gets extra rest after beating Navy 28-24 (-13) last Thursday. HC Drinkwitz is just 4-11 as a favorite and 3-9 ATS vs non-conf foes at Mizzou. Memphis has won 6 of their last 9 vs Power-5 teams in the regular season and we think they are catching Missouri at just the right time. **FORECAST: Memphis by 3**

**TCU by 3 over Smu** - 102nd battle of the Iron Skillet. The L/3 mtgs have all been decided by 8 pts or less. LY TCU (-2) never trailed at SMU in a 42-34 win where the yds were nearly even but SMU was -2 TO's. SMU is 2-1 on the year & played OU close 2 wks ago holding them to just 365 yds & 28 pts, while TCU got a B12 win LW at Houston 36-13 where they put up 564 yds and held them to 266. Overall TCU is all'g just 61 rush ypg (1.8) and have 13 sks, while SMU is giving up just 104 rush (2.8) and they have 10 sks. These tms apper evenly matched and the home team is on an 0-7-1 ATS run and have lost outright 4 straight times. While we see TCU winning, SMU will get the cover. **NEBRASKA by 17 over Louisiana Tech** - 1st meeting since 2006. LA Tech is 5-3 ATS vs B10 teams. Nebraska was upset at home last season by non-Power 5 foe GA Southern (45-42, -23) and new HC Rhule is 12-13 as a HF. The Huskers got Rhule his 1st win last week with a 35-11 (-13) as they held NIU to just 149 ttl yds and are now allowing just 46 rush ypg (1.7) this year. LA Tech allowed 562 yds in their 40-37 (-4) home loss to North Texas last week and has struggled to stop the run, allowing 205 (4.9) rush ypg. Nebraska has Michigan on deck and we aren't quite ready to trust them as a 3 td favorite, so we'll take the Bulldogs getting the points in this one.

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 8 over Tulsa** - First mtg was LY in Tulsa and the home team escaped with a 38-35 (-6.5) win as they outgained NIU 429-385 and scored the game-winning td with under a minute left. This, however, is a much different Tulsa team under new HC Kevin Wilson. The Golden Hurricane have already used 3 QB's due to injury and Roman Fuller started last week in their 66-17 (-28) loss to Oklahoma and Tulsa is allowing 579 total ypg to FBS foes. After upsetting Boston College in the opener, Northern Illinois has lost 2 straight after a 35-11 (+13) loss at Nebraska in which they were held to 149 ttl yds. NIU is only 3-9 as a HF under HC Hammock, but this is a young Tulsa team with some uncertainty at QB so we'll side with the home team giving over a td.

**KANSAS ST by 10 over Ucf** - Only prior meeting came back in 2010 when KSt (-6) hosted UCF and only won 17-13. KSt is off a last-second loss at Mizzou where they allowed 430 yds and QB Howard was noticeably limping in the 2H. UCF was without QB Plumlee LW and he won't be available here and the backup is former USF QB Timmy McClain, who threw for 321 LW, but this is atougher test. KSt is on a 7-1 ATS run as a home favorite, while this is UCF's Big 12 opener. We have been impressed with KSt this season, but if QB Howard is less than 100% that hurts the KSt offense. We still think KSt wins but this game could be closer if Howard is a no-go.

**ALABAMA by 13 over Ole Miss** - Bama is 7-0 SU but only 3-4 ATS vs Ole Miss. LTH Kiffin said "Get your popcorn ready" then Ole Miss proceeded to fall behind 35-0 and lost by 21. Bama tried to spark the offense by switching QB's last week but failed miserably, putting up just 310 yds and 17 points vs USF. The game was played in wet/rainy conditions but it's hard to say which of 3 QB's starts this week vs Bama. Ole Miss has won B2B games with misleading finals. They were tied with Tulane to start the 4Q but won by 17 then LW only led GT 34-27 but scored 24 points in the last 7:45. RB Judkins is battling an injury and was ineffective again, rushing for just 37 yards but QB Dart had 136 rush. Bama's 128 week streak of being in the AP Top 10 ended, but they are still 13-6-1 as HF and we don't mind backing Saban laying less than a td in Tuscaloosa.

**TEXAS ST by 24 over Nevada** - 3rd meeting. Met last season in Reno where TXSt (E) had the yds edge but were -4 TO's and lost 38-14. Nevada is avg'g just 313 ypg on offense and fell to FCS Idaho at home 33-6 (-197 yds) 2 wks ago but only lost vs KU by 7 pts LW. Nevada is allowing 524 ypg and 43 ppg overall and their pass D is giving up 74% completions and 355 pass ypg! TXSt is putting up 265 pass ypg led by QB Finley and last week they scored 77 pts & gained 684 yds vs Jackson St! The TXSt D also has all'd just 128 rush ypg & have collected 14 sks! We expect TXSt to air the ball out here and dominate Nevada by over 3 td's at home. GJ Kinne's avg win last year at Incarnate Word was by 32 ppg as he's known for running it up and will have an opportunity to do that here.

**Texas by 17 over BAYLOR** - Texas has won 6 of the L/8 mtgs SU and have covered 5 of the L/8 mtgs. LY's 38-27 win by Texas broke a streak of 9 straight "Unders" in the series. Texas struggled vs WY last week, as the game was 10-10 into the 4Q before Texas scored 21 straight to win 31-10. Baylor beat FCS Long Island 30-7 but did not cover (-45) as bkp QB Robertson was just 10-22 for 113. While the home team has won and covered 4 straight in the series, Texas appears like the much stronger team & BU is not playing well early on and could still be w/o QB Shapen (check status) so we like Texas here by over 2 td's.

**TROY by 4 over Wku** - Last year Troy Troy was a 5' pt underdog and pulled the outright upset, beating WKU 34-27, ending WKU's streak of 38 straight games with 30+ points. WKU was no match for Ohio St last week in a 63-10 loss (+30). QB Reed threw for 406 in last year's loss to Troy. The Trojans have lost B2B including LW to James Madison 16-14 (-2). They allowed 6 sacks and were held to -12 rush yds. Troy's offense should fair much better against a WKU D that is allowing 36 ppg and are #129 in the FBS, allowing 490 ypg. Troy has a big edge on defense but WKU is 10-5 as an AD and always have backdoor potential with their potent offense.

**LOUISIANA by 16 over Buffalo** - First mtg. Bulls are 3-3 SU but 4-2 ATS vs SBC teams s/2018. While the Cajuns failed to cover in TY's opener as a 35 pt HF vs an FCS team (won 38-13) they were 4-0 ATS as a home favorite LY including a 49-21 win over MAC foe EM as an 11' pt HF. LW the Cajuns looked impressive going on the road and pulling a 41-21 outright upset at UAB as a 2' pt AD. The Bulls are off an ugly 55-27 loss to Liberty as a 3' pt HD being outgained 569-363. Louisiana is 2-1 but has a tough trip to Minnesota on deck so look for them to concentrate on the Bulls. Buffalo is 0-3 SU (1-2 ATS) including a loss to an FCS foe & has their MAC opener on deck. LA is also running for 228 (6.0) and face a Buffalo run D all'g 230 ypg (5.8). We like LA to win by over 2 td's.

**TEXAS A&M by 13 over Auburn** - The home team had lost 8 of 9 meetings from '12-'20 but has won the last two SU/ATS. A&M has shown a vastly improved offense this year, putting up 44 ppg and 467 ypg. Auburn struggled on offense two weeks ago at Cal, putting up just 230 yards and are off a 45-13 (-33) win over FCS Samford but it was 0-0 after 1Q. QB Thorne isn't known for his running ability but had 123 rush LW vs a weak FCS D. This will be Throne's first SEC road start and we think the home crowd plays a factor. We have the Aggies with the edge on offense and defense and will call for A&M to win by over a touchdown.

**Eastern Michigan by 3 over JACKSONVILLE ST** - First meeting and JSU plays a MAC team for the first time. JSU enters fresh off a bye after losing at Coastal Carolina 30-16 (+13). They have a big CUSA game on deck with fellow FCS import Sam Houston. EMich has stuck to their usual script

this year, covering as a dog 2 wks ago at Minnesota but allowing Howard and UMass to keep it closer than expected. The Eagles were outgained 464-371 last week vs UMass but won 19-17 (-7). It's pretty simple, take EMich as an away dog as they are 25-6 in that role.

**New Mexico St by 1 over HAWAII** - UH has won 10 of the 11 mtgs SU, but LY was NMSt's first win over them as they led 35-10 HT and won 46-25 (-4). LY's win by NMSt also broke an 0-6 ATS streak by the home team. NMSt got to 2-2 on the season with a 27-17 win at NMex last week despite getting outgained & being -11 FD's! UH is off to a 1-3 start, with their lone win coming vs Albany and their losses are to 3 Power 5 tms by 7, 13 and 45 pts. UH's OLine has already all'd 16 sks in 4 gms & UH is running for just 52 ypg. NMSt is led by QB Pavia (64%, 8-4) and they are avg'g 462 ypg overall. While UH has covered 7 of their L/8 home gms, all but one of those covers was as a dog and they are a slight favorite here & we think NMSt gets the narrow win.

**Liberty by 7 over FIU** - Lib is making their first trip to FIU in their first ever CUSA road opener. The Flames enter 3-0 after beating Buffalo 55-27 (-3) and had a 569-363 yd edge. FIU has won all 3 games with true frosh QB Keyone "Lights Out" Jenkins starting, upsetting UConn last week 24-17 (+7) and they actually led 24-3 at half with a 297-119 yd edge. HC McIntyre has FIU 3-0 ATS as underdogs this year while Liberty comes in 3-0 as favorites. The Flames are already +8 TO's so far while FIU is only -1. This could be high scoring and we like the underdog Panthers to stay within a score.

**FLORIDA by 21 over Charlotte** - 1st meeting. Charlotte is 1-8 SU, but 4-4 ATS vs Power 5 foes since '15, including a cover vs Maryland earlier this year. Florida is 6-0 SU, but 1-5 ATS vs non-Power 5 teams since '21. The Gators upset Tenn 29-16 (+5) last week to give HC Napier a signature win in his 2nd year. Charlotte is off a 41-25 (+7) loss to GA St and has allowed over 500 yards in both games against FBS teams. Florida is of their big win over Tenn and has Kentucky on deck, plus Florida is just 6-13-1 as a DD favorite recently so we like the 49ers to keep this one within the line.

**WYOMING by 6 over Appalachian St** - 3rd meeting. Last met in '15 at App St, where they won 31-13 over WY. They also met here in 2004 and WY won that game 53-7. WY was tied with Texas 10-10 4Q before all'g 21 straight 4Q pts but are off to a 2-1 start incl a home upset of Texas Tech in the opener. App did beat ECU LW 43-28 as QB Aguilar had 4 total td's. WY is holding tms to 123 rush ypg (3.5) and their D has 8 sks. WY likes to run the ball (165, 4.1) and App St is all'g 176 rush ypg (5.1). WY did start QB Svoboda LW (Peasley out w/ shoulder inj, status here?). WY is 10-2 SU in non-conf home games since '16 with losses to Wash St & Oregon & with this line near a FG all WY really has to do is win & we think they will by almost a full td with the elevation edge.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 6 over Colorado St** - LY was the only other mtg, as CSU (-11) was down 27-0 HT (35-350) and lost 34-19. This season CSU is off to an 0-2 start, but nearly upset Colorado LW in Boulder (43-35 loss in 2OT). CSU started backup QB Fowler-Nicolosi and he threw for 367 & 3 td's but did have 3 int's. MT got their 1st win of the season over Murray St 35-14. CSU has struggled against the pass early on TY, all'g 814 yds in 2 gms while MT is avg'g 213 pass ypg led by QB Vattiato (69%, 5-2 ratio). LW was an emotional game for CSU and off that game they could be flat and we like MT by almost a full td.

**HOUSTON by 7 over Sam Houston** - These campuses are just 70 miles apart. SH has covered a remarkable 11 straight as underdogs including their first two FBS games, despite scoring just 3 total points. UH is just 1-7 as a HF. Their D held both BYU and Air Force below 260 yards! This game is a Big 12 Sandwich for UH, coming off a 36-13 (+7) loss to TCU and they have Texas Tech on deck. SH had the bye week to fix some of their offensive woes and they clearly have the defense to compete. SH will be the more motivated team so we say take the points.

**NOTRE DAME by 3 over Ohio St** - Teams met in Columbus last year, their 1st non-bowl meeting since 1996. The Irish led 10-7 at HT with a 181-149 yard edge, but the Buckeyes scored 2 tds in the 2H and held ND to just 72 ttl yards after the half in their 21-10 (-16) win. OSU got their offense in gear last week vs WKU as they amassed 562 ttl yds in their 63-10 (-30) win. The Buckeyes are now allowing just 7 ppg (#2 in NCAA). Notre Dame moved to 4-0 with a 41-17 (-34) win over C Mich. New Irish QB Sam Hartman has thrown for 1,061 (71%) with a 13-0 ratio and the Irish are averaging 46 ppg and 509 ypg. The Irish are 6-2 ATS as a HD since 2013 and we think the Irish will do just enough on offense to come away with a statement win in HC Marcus Freeman's 2nd year.

**PENN ST by 17 over Iowa** - Penn St won 6 in a row over Iowa from '11-'19, but the Hawkeyes have won the last 2, including a 41-21 (-1) win LTH here in '20. The home team has failed to cover in 2 of the last 3 in the series. The Nittany Lions are 3-0 SU/ATS and are off a 30-13 (-14) road win over Illinois in which they were +5 in turnovers. PSU is allowing just 12 ppg and are holding opponents to 97 (3.1) rush ypg. Iowa also enters 3-0 (2-1 ATS) off their 41-10 (-28) win over W Mich. QB McNamara threw for just 103 with a 2-2 ratio and the Hawkeyes are averaging just 151 pass ypg. With Iowa struggling to throw the ball and Penn St strong against the run, this is a tough matchup for the Hawkeyes, so we like the Nittany Lions at home in their "White Out" game.

**UTEP by 3 over Unlv** - UNLV won the only recent meeting 52-24 in '18 but makes their first trip to El Paso since 1993. The Rebels are off their 2nd upset win over Vandy. In '19 they upset the 'Dores then proceeded to lose their next 4 games. UNLV trailed Vandy 17-0 2Q last week but scored 30 straight and got a 36 yd fg to win 40-37 (+4). UTEP lost at Arizona 31-10 (+19). The Miners kept it close for a half vs a Power-5 for a 2nd straight week but ran out of gas. HC Dimel badly needs this win for their bowl hopes and UNLV could be w/o starting QB Brumfield.

**FRESNO ST by 24 over Kent St** - First matchup. KSU got their first win of the season LW vs C. Conn St 38-10 but lost their F/2 gms vs P5 foes by a comb'd score of 84-12 and gained a total of 440 yds in those gms. Fresno is off to a 3-0 start and have a pair of wins over P5 tms (Purdue, Ariz St). In LW's win vs Ariz St the Bulldogs were +8 TO's but only had 15 pts off those TO's and won 29-0. KSU gave up 334 pass yds to UCF in the opener, now face a former UCF QB here in Keene, who is hitting 65% (8-2 ratio) and the Bulldog D is holding tms to 320 ypg. Kent St used a clock burning strategy vs Ark 2 weeks ago and we think they do the same to keep it closer.

## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ SEATTLE over Carolina** - The Panthers head to the Pacific NW on short rest following a MNF home meeting with the Saints (lost by 2 TD's in the ssn opener at ATL). The Seahawks meanwhile picked up an OT road win LW in DET with QB Geno Smith throwing for 328 yards and 2 TD's. The Seahawks saw their 3-game winning streak against the Panthers snapped LY at home as CAR (+3) finished with 24-16 FD and 328-287 yd edges in the 30-24 victory. While the Seahawks are a porous 1-5 ATS as a HF, it's hard to back rookie QB Bryce Young making his first trip to the home of the "12th Man."

**3★ LAS VEGAS over Pittsburgh - SNF** - This marks the only HG in the 1st 4 weeks of the season for the Raiders who return to "Sin City" following a 28 pt loss in BUF where they were held to just 10 pts, 13 FD's and 240 yards. The Steelers meanwhile are on the road for the first time TY and on short rest to boot after a MNF meeting against the Browns. In their trip to PIT a year ago, the Raiders (+1) had 19-13 FD and 350-201 yd disadvantages in a 13-10 defeat. While the Steelers are on a solid 6-2 ATS run, the Raiders (actually a small dog as of presstime) have done well in recent home contests with a 7-3 ATS mark!

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ MINNESOTA over LA Chargers** - Following a narrow OT loss LW in Nashville where they were without star RB Ekeler due to an ankle injury (CS here), the Chargers are back on the road to take on a well-rested and angry group of Vikings that dropped their 2nd straight contest last Thur in Philly where the Eagles jumped out to a 27-7 lead in the 3Q of their eventual 6 pt win (MIN 7 TO's over 1st 2 qms). The Chargers have dropped 3 consecutive meetings against the Vikings (SU & ATS, 18 pt avg defeat) including a 27-20 (-3) home loss in '21 where MIN finished with 24-20 FD and 381-253 yd edges. With the Vikings covering 7 of their past 10 contests against the AFC along with their recent success against the Chargers, the home team gets the edge in this one assuming they don't cough up the ball yet again.

**FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 8**

## OTHER PLAYS

**NY Giants at SAN FRANCISCO - Thursday** - It was a tale of 2 halves for the Giants who trailed 20-0 at HT before outscoring the Cardinals 31-8 in the 2H to get the miracle victory (NYG's biggest comeback s/1950, QB Jones 380 ttl yds, 3 TD's). They're now back on the NFC West road for a 2nd straight week to take on a 49ers squad in Santa Clara for the first time TY after B2B road wins over the Steelers (391-239 yd edge in 23 pt victory) and Rams (RB McCaffrey 116 rush yds in 7 pt victory). The all-time series between these 2 is split at 21 games apiece with the 49ers easily picking up the most recent matchup in '20 with a 36-9 (-3) road victory (29-13 FD & 420-231 yd edges). While SF is an outstanding 10-1 ATS as home chalk, also keep in mind that the Giants have covered 25 of their past 36 as an AD. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

**CLEVELAND by 2 over Tennessee** - The Browns return home after a MNF trip against the Steelers. They now take on a Titans squad that's sitting at 1-1 after narrow loss to the Saints (1 pt defeat) and an OT victory over the Chargers. Following a 3-game losing skid from '16-'19, the Browns (+4) went into Nashville in '20 and came away with a 41-35 shootout victory (led 38-7 at HT). While we do expect CLE to get the win in this one, laying a FG or more is a bit risky as the Browns have failed to cover 6 of their L/8 as a NDIV HF while the Titans are 10-4-1 ATS as an AD.

**JACKSONVILLE by 4 over Houston** - After an 11 pt home loss against the Colts a week ago where rookie QB Stroud threw for 384 yards and 2 TD's, the Texans head East to take on a Jags squad that struggled offensively in a loss against the Chiefs (just 3 FG's and 271 yds). After 9 consecutive losses to the Texans dating back to the start of '18 (2-7 ATS), the Jags (-3) dominated LY's Wk 17 trip to HOU with a 31-3 victory (JAX 20-13 FD & 377-277 yd edges). Despite that victory, keep in mind that JAX has failed to cover all 6 regular season games as home chalk the L3Y. The Jaguars also have a 2-week trip to London on deck while the Texans have covered 10 of their L/15 meetings against DIV foes.

**New England by 6 over NY JETS** - The Patriots are sitting at 0-2 for the first time since 2001 (Belichick's 2nd ssn) following a 7 pt home defeat against the Dolphins where they were outgained 389-288. They now head on the road for the first time this season to take on a Jets squad that suffered a 20 pt defeat LW in DAL with the Cowboys forcing 4 TO's and allowing just 12 FD's and 215 yards. The Patriots have won 14 straight matchups against the Jets (10-4 ATS, 18 pt avg MOV) including a 5 pt win (-3) at MetLife a year ago where they had a 387-288 yard disadvantage. With the Jets failing to cover 22 of the past 32 against AFC East foes, we'll go ahead and lay the points with the visitor in this one.

**GREEN BAY by 7 over New Orleans** - The Saints are on the road for a 2nd straight week following a MNF trip to Charlotte to take on the Panthers. The Packers meanwhile are in Lambeau for the first time this season after a convincing win over the Bears in Wk 1 followed by a loss in ATL where they blew a 24-12 lead in the 4Q (Falcons 27-17 FD & 446-224 yd edges). The last meeting between these 2 was moved away from the "Big Easy" due to a hurricane. The change of venue (Jacksonville) was no issue for the Saints however as they handed the Packers a 38-3 (+3) beatdown thanks to 5 TD passes from Jameis Winston (NO 22-14 FD & 322-229 yd edges). While the Saints have gone 12-4 ATS as an AD, we're leaning with the "Cheeseheads" here as the Saints are traveling on short rest and GB is an outstanding 8-1-1 ATS in home openers.

**MIAMI by 10 over Denver** - This marks the only HG in the first 4 weeks of the ssn for the Dolphins who return to South Beach following a 7 pt victory in Foxboro where QB Tagovailoa (21-30-249-1-1) moved to 5-0 all-time against Bill Belichick. The Broncos meanwhile are on the road for the first time TY after coughing up a 21-3 lead in the 2Q against the Commanders LW in "Mile High" with WAS sacking QB Wilson 7 times! The Broncos have collected wins in 3 of the past 4 against the Dolphins including a 20-13 (+4) victory in '20 (DEN 459-223 yd edge). DEN has also covered 8 of their past 11 when listed as a NDIV AD. Despite that impressive mark, we're leaning in the home team's direction in this one as the Dolphins are 10-4 ATS as home chalk and have looked impressive in their first 2 games of the year.

**Buffalo by 10 over WASHINGTON** - Rematch of SB XXVI ('91 ssn) where WAS delivered a 37-24 victory. Since that "Big Game" winner by WAS, the Bills have collected wins in 8 of the past 9 including a 43-21 (-7) victory in '21 where QB Josh Allen finished with 367 ttl yds and 5 TD's. Following a rough ending on MNF against the Jets in Wk 1, the Bills earned a 28-pt home victory LW against the Raiders with large edges in both FD's (29-13) and yards (450-240). The Commanders meanwhile return home after overcoming a 21-3 deficit in the 2Q in the eventual 2 pt victory (Broncos Hail Mary TD w/00 left but missed tying 2 pt conv). The Bills have gone a solid 12-6 ATS against the NFC coming in which has us leaning in their direction here as the Commanders have failed to cover 5 of their L/7 overall despite LW's outstanding comeback.

**DETROIT by 9 over Atlanta** - The Lions dropped an OT matchup against the Seahawks LW at home in a contest that saw us cash another 3★ Newsletter Winner on the "Over". The Falcons meanwhile are sitting at 2-0 on the year (1st time s/17) after overcoming a 12 pt deficit in the 4Q by scoring 13 consec points including a GW 25-yd FG w/1:01 left (ATL 27-17 FD & 446-224 yd edges). In their most recent meeting back in '21, the Falcons (-7) picked up a 20-16 home victory despite the Lions

finishing with 19-14 FD and 338-254 yd edges. With ATL failing to cover 10 of their L/13 overall coming in and the Lions on a very impressive 10-2 ATS run, we'll give DET the lean here as they've also covered 4 of their past 6 as home chalk.

**BALTIMORE by 7 over Indianapolis** - Following a big DIV road win LW in Cincy where QB Jackson finished with 291 ttl yards and a pair of TD's, the Ravens return home to take on a Colts squad that picked up an 11 pt road win in HOU despite losing rookie QB Richardson to injury for a 2nd straight week (bkp Minshew 19-23-171-1-0 in relief). After dropping 8 straight from '02-'09, the Ravens have come out on top in 5 of the L/6 including a 31-25 (-7) OT victory in '21 where Lamar Jackson threw for 442 yds and 4 TD's. Despite that recent run, we're cutting off our lean at a TD for the Ravens as they've failed to cover 7 of their L/9 as a HF while the Colts have gone an impressive 8-3 ATS as a NDIV AD.

**Dallas by 14 over ARIZONA** - The Cowboys have looked like the strongest team in the NFL the first 2 weeks of the season following a 40-0 road win against the Giants in Wk 1 followed by a 30-10 home victory over the Jets LW where they had 26-12 FD and 382-215 yard edges (+4 TO's). The Cardinals meanwhile are sitting at 0-2 on the year after blowing a 20-0 HT lead LW in the desert against the Giants (ARZ 439-379 yd deficit). Surprisingly, the Cardinals have recorded victories in 6 of the L/7 (SU & ATS) against DAL including a 25-22 (+6) road win in '21 where they finished with 23-19 FD and 399-301 yd edges. Despite that recent success, we're leaning with the visitor in this one as DAL has gone 8-3 ATS as an AF and clearly look like the stronger team.

**KANSAS CITY by 7 over Chicago** - The Chiefs' defense put together a stifling performance LW on the road in their victory over the Jags by allowing just 271 yds and 3 FG's in the 17-9 win. The Bears are still in search of their first win in '23 following a Wk 1 loss at home in GB and a 10 pt loss LW in Tampa where they were outgained by a 437-236 yard clip against the Bucs. The Bears and Chiefs have alternated wins since 1987 with KC recording the most recent victory in '19 (26-3 road win, 25-18 FD & 350-234 yd edges). While the Chiefs are 6-1 ATS in regular season meetings with the NFC, laying more than a TD could be risky as CHI is 8-3-1 ATS in non-conf matchups.

**Philadelphia at TAMPA BAY - MNF** - The Eagles head to Tampa with extra rest following a 6 pt home win last Thur against the Vikings where they put up 259 yards on the ground (5.4) and finished with a 4-1 TO advantage. The Bucs meanwhile are also surprisingly sitting at 2-0 after a 10 pt home victory against the Bears where QB Mayfield threw for 317 yards and a TD. The Bucs have recorded 4 consecutive wins (3-1 ATS) including a playoff win in '21 where they led 31-0 entering the 4Q (PHI 2 late TD's). While they have also gone 11-3-1 ATS as a HD, this will be the toughest defense they face so far. **LA Rams at CINCINNATI - MNF** - Rematch of SB LVI ('21 ssn) where the Rams got a GW 1-yd TD pass with 1:25 remaining. Following the only HG over the 1st 4 weeks where they suffered a 7 pt defeat against the 49ers (LAR 386-365 yd edge, -2 TO's), the Rams head East to take on a Bengals squad that needs to get back on track here after B2B defeats to the Browns (lost 24-3 in Wk 1 at CLE) and Ravens (3 pt home loss, BAL 26-19 FD & 415-282 yd edges). Prior to their "Big Game" meeting, the Bengals had won 3 of 4 against the Rams. While CIN has also gone an impressive 5-1 ATS as a HF while covering 8 of their past 10 overall dating back to LY, the Rams have already won outright as a 5 pt AD just 2 weeks ago against the Seahawks.
