4★ TULANE over Uab - 1st meeting since 2021 when UAB pulled a 28-21 (+3.5) upset at Tulane. UAB has struggled to a 1-3 (2-2 ATS) start under new HC Trent Dilfer, including a 49-21 (+40) loss to #1 Georgia last week. The Blazers defense has been the biggest issue as they have allowed at least 460 yds to all 3 FBS foes. QB Jacob Zeno has been a relative bright spot as he's hitting 75% for 1206 yds with a 8-4 ratio. Tulane is off to a 3-1 start with the only loss to Ole Miss when the Wave played without starting QB Pratt. Pratt returned last week vs FCS Nicholls and the Wave cruised to a 36-7 (-35) win. Tulane's defense has been stout against run, allowing just 63 rush ypg (#5 NCAA). The Tulane offense is back to full strength and that's bad news for a UAB team that can't stop anyone so the Green Wave, who are on a 16-4 ATS run gets the call! **FORECAST: TULANE by 34**

3★ TEXAS TECH over Houston - Teams have met 34 times and s/10 TT is 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS against UH. LY TT led 17-3 HT but then needed a late 4Q FG to send the game to OT and they won it in 2 OT's. UH is off their best performance of the season LW as they put up 538 yds & 38 pts on Sam Houston. UH QB Smith faces his old team here & he is off his best gm of the ssn, as he hit 78% with 294 yds. TT dropped to 1-3 LW after falling to WVU 20-13 despite all'g just 256 yds & being +2 TO's (TT SOD 3 times) and QB Shough left the gm, but bkp Morton has exp. The offense is avg'g 406 ypg but are hitting just 54% of their passes, while the DEF is holding tms to 56 ypg under their avg & the pass D has held 3 tms to under 200 pass yds. UH beat up on a bad SHStm & here on the road in front of a big crowd vs a TT team needing a win, we see the Red Raiders winning by nearly 3 tds.

FORECAST: TEXAS TECH by 20

3★ NEBRASKA (+) over Michigan - Michigan has won 3 straight in the series, but have failed to cover in 3 straight as the last 2 meetings ended in ATS ties. LTH in '21, Nebraska almost pulled the outright upset of #9 Michigan as they led 29-26 in the 4th, but the Wolverines kicked 2 fgs in the last 3 mins to escape with a 32-29 (-3) win. The Huskers have been running the ball well gaining 235 ypg on the ground and have been stopping the run on defense, allowing just 46 ypg and haven't allowed more than 58 rush yds. Michigan is off a 31-7 (-24) home win over Rutgers. The Wolverines allowed a td on Rutgers 1st possession, but scored 31 unanswered to get the win. The Wolverines have been less than impressive so far this year and hasn't been able to cover big lines at home, so we don't expect them to cover more than 2 tds on the road.

FORECAST: Michigan by 9

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Notre Dame over DUKE - The Irish have won 28 straight vs ACC foes (20-8 ATS) including 9 straights covers, and have already beat NCSt 45-17 (-7) earlier this year. ND is off a physical loss to Ohio St 17-14 (+3). ND backers took a bad beat considering the final td play started with :03 left and "only took 2 seconds" which forced OSU to kick the PAT and push. Duke didn't look ahead last week when they beat UConn 41-7 (-22). They only put up 322 yards, scoring 3 tds on drives of less than 50 yds and a fumble ret td. Duke is 8-1 ATS at home under Elko but we think this is a cheap line thanks to Duke's misleading 28-7 win over Clemson in the opener. This game actually means more to ND who can still get in the playoff conversation if they run the table but Duke's focus is making the ACC Title game. ND is also on a 10-3-1 ATS run as an AF! Gameday is on hand which is actually a distraction for some teams and we think the Irish come in fully focused off a loss. **FORECAST: Notre Dame by 17**

2★ Iowa over MICHIGAN ST - MSU had won 3 straight in the series from '12-'17, but Iowa laid the smack down LTH in '20 with a 49-7 (-5) win with a commanding 405-286 yd edge. This is a far different offensive team for Iowa this year. The Hawkeyes were held to just 76 total yds by Penn St last week in their 31-0 (+14) road loss and are now averaging just 246 ypg and have been held under 300 yds in 3 of their 4 games. Michigan St (2-2 SU/ATS) is off a 31-9 (+14) home loss to Maryland in which they actually outgained the Terps 376-362 but were -4 in TOs as 2 Spartan QBs combined to throw for 3 ints. Iowa is off a physical game and was 4-1 ATS off a SU loss LY while Michigan St is being outscored by 28 ppg vs Power 5 teams, so we'll ride with the home team. **FORECAST: IOWA by 18**

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 28th

WKU by 6 over Middle Tennessee - This is the 73rd meeting in the '100 miles of hate' series. WKU has won 7 of the last 8 including 4 straight. The last two wins have come by 18 and 27. WKU enters off B2B losses to Ohio St and Troy. The 'Toppers D has allowed over 500 yards to all 3 FBS foes they've faced including 521 last week. MT is 1-3 but two of their losses were to SEC foes and last week they outgained Colorado St 430-378. Down 31-23 (+3) MT reached the CSU 32 but was SOD on the final play. WKU has the edge on offense but they've been held under 300 yards in B2B games. MT has a big edge on D and has faced a tougher schedule but they are just #128 in our pass D Efficiency rankings (71%, 9-1). We will take the points in a high scoring game.

Temple by 3 over TULSA - 1st AAC game for both teams. Tulsa has won the last 2 in the series (1-1 ATS), including a 27-16 (+13) win at Temple last year. The also beat the Owls 44-10 (-22) LTH here in '21. The Hurricane come into this one at 1-3 (1-2-1 ATS) off their 22-14 (+4) win over at NIU, which gave HC Kevin Wilson his first win as HC here. Tulsa got the win despite being held to 281 total yds including 102 through the air. Temple is off a 41-9 (+24) home loss to Miami, FL that moved them to 2-2 (1-3 ATS). The Owls were held to 279 total yds and are now averaging just 310 ypg vs FBS foes. We think the Owls are the better team and they finished last year on a 2-0 ATS run as a conf AD, so we like them to win this one outright.

Jacksonville St by 3 over SAM HOUSTON - Battle of two teams who moved up from FCS this season. This is SH's home opener after a brutal first 3 games vs BYU, Air Force and Houston. SH has just 1 td all season and are off a 31 pt loss to Houston but did keep it closer than expected in their first 2 gms. JSU is 3-1, having already won their CUSA opener in week 0 vs UTEP. The Gamecocks were outgained in that game but have held the yds edge in all 3 since including LW vs EMich 388-152 and won 21-0 (-7). JSU has clearly looked better on the field, but SH has played a MUCH tougher schedule (#9 vs #130). This should be a fired up home crowd for their first CUSA game, on television and SH has the D to keep this close, having held BYU and AF to 27 combined points and under 260 yards.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 29th

NC STATE by 3 over Louisville - Last year NCSt was down to their 3rd string QB on the road and lost 25-10 (+3) but 2 years ago won at home 28-13 (-6). NCSt never trailed last week but was also never covering as an 8' pt AF vs UVA. The Wolfpack needed a 33 yd fg on the final play to win 24-21 and they were outgained 384-319. QB Armstrong has been better this year but still not living up to expectations with just a 5-4 ratio. UL scored td's on their first 6 possessions LW and beat BC 56-28 (-14). QB Plummer threw for 388 yards with 5 td passes but he does face a stiffer test in NCSt's D led by CB Aydan White who had an int LW. NCSt has the edge on D and ST's and a few weeks ago only trailed ND 24-17 to start the 4Q. We like the 'Pack to win a close game.

UTEP by 3 over Louisiana Tech - UTEP is just 2-12 SU in the series but 8-6 ATS. LT was w/o QB Bachmeier last week at Neb but they only lost 28-14 (+20). UTEP suffered their 3rd straight loss, 45-28 (+1) to UNLV. QB Hardison threw 3 int's and has a 5-7 ratio and their Oline which is supposed to be a strength has allowed 14 sacks. LT has been gashed for 227 rush ypg (5.2) and in UTEP's

only win they rushed for 329. UTEP has two RB's averaging over 5 ypc. The Miners are 12-4 SU at home since '20 while LT is 0-16 SU/4-12 ATS on the road so we are giving UTEP a 3 pt edge.

OREGON ST by 6 over Utah - Following their 1st loss of the ssn LW on the road in Pullman where WSU had a 17 pt lead in the 4Q before a late charge by OSU (38-35 defeat, all'd 528 td yds after being ranked 13th in FBS in ttl D), the Beavers return to Reser Stadium where they've lost just once in their past 15 contests (14-1 ATS). They now play host to a Utes squad that picked up a 7 pt home victory LW in SLC vs the Bruins without QB Rising once again (UCLA 243-219 yd edge. Utes all'd just 1 off TD for 4th consec wk). Utah has won 6 of the past 7 meetings vs OSU (3-4 ATS) including a 42-16 (-10) home win LY (led just 21-16 mid 3Q before scoring 21 unanswered pts). With the Utes posting just a 4-9 ATS run in recent away games and Oregon ST coming in with a ridiculous 14-1 ATS record at home we can't help but lean with the home Beavers.

BYU by 1 over Cincinnati - Only have met 2 times, back in '15 Cincy won 38-24 (-6) at home and in '16 Cincy (-7) won 20-3 on the road. Despite avg'g just 325 ypg on offense BYU is 3-1 on the season, as their defense is giving up 327 ypg, however gave up 221 rush yds (6.0) to Kansas LW. Cincy is off a 20-6 home loss to OU where they allowed 322 pass yds, but all'd just 103 rush (3.0) and overall are all'g 108 rush ypg (3.5) and BYU is running for just 61 ypg (2.2). While Cincy will have to deal with the elevation in Provo, BYU is on a 1-6 ATS run as a HF and Cincy already has a road win at Pitt and we think the UC D and strong run game (215, 4.8) will keep this gm close.

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 30th

Penn St by 35 over NORTHWESTERN - PSU has won 8 of the last 10 in the series but NWest has covered 3 of the last 4, including a 17-7 (+25.5) loss in Happy Valley last year in which they held the Nittany Lions to just 140 pass yds. The Wildcats are off a big 37-34 (+11) home upset win over Minnesota. NWest trailed 31-10 in the 4Q but got the game tying td with :02 left to push it to OT where they eventually prevailed. Penn St is off a dominant 31-0 (-14) home win over Iowa, in which they held the Hawkeyes to just 76 total yds! The Lions featured a balanced attack as they rushed for 224 (3.9) and threw for 182. Prior to last week, NWest was averaging just 286 ypg and the PSU defense is a different beast, so we'll take the Nittany Lions by 5 tds in this one.

GEORGIA TECH by 24 over Bowling Green - GT won the only prior meeting 63-17 (-28) in '18. BG is 3-1 ATS vs Power-5's in the last 3 years. HC Key took over GT is 8-4 ATS and they just upset WF on the road 30-16 (+3). Haynes King has an 11-2 ratio and the Jackets are averaging 480 ypg (97 ypg more than foes allow on avg!) GT had a misleading final vs Ole Miss 2 weeks ago (trail by 7 Q4, lost by 25) & only lost to 4-0 Lville by 4 in the opener. Now they face BG who has 3 losses by double-digits and only avgr 312 ypg. The Falcons 3 QB's combine for a 4-9 ratio and GT is allowing just 54.5% completions and 189 pass ypg with a 5-5 ratio (#30 in pass D Efficiency), having faced UL's Plummer and Ole Miss' Dart. The Jackets won't overlook this game as a win here puts them over .500 for the first time since '18 and gets them closer to bowl eligibility.

Clemson by 5 over SYRACUSE - Syracuse has given Clemson fits, covering 7 of the last 10 meetings although last year's game was misleading. Clemson won 27-21 (-14) but the game largely swung early when the Tigers fumbled going in for a td and Cuse ret'd it for 99 yds for a 14 pt swing. Clemson had a 429-311 yd edge LW vs FSU but their kicking woes (now 2-6) came back to bite them when recently unretired walk-on Weitz missed a chip shot with 1:45 left. Clemson also allowed a fumble return td. Cuse was in a look-ahead spot last week and trailed at half but still beat Army 29-16 (-13). Cuse has faced the weakest schedule in the country but Clemson has played our #44 sked rank and outgained both Duke and FSU in losses. We think Clemson wins but this has traditionally been a close game with a slight lean to the underdog.

CONNECTICUT by 1 over Utah St - Met LY at USU where the Aggies (-26) led just 24-14 at the half and only won by 11 pts. Only mtg here was back in '01 and USU (-15) won 38-31. UConn is off to an 0-4 start on the season, and their offense is only putting up 286 ypg and 13 ppg, but have played two P5 teams and a GAST team that is unbeaten. USU comes in 1-3 TY after a 45-38 home loss to JMU where they allowed 512 yards and are now playing true frosh QB Hillstead, but he threw for 399 yds and 4 td's, but did throw 3 int's. While USU has played better TY, the Aggies are traveling cross country for this game & it is a noon kickoff, plus they have a MW game on deck, so we'll call for UConn to get the upset & their 1st win of the ssn.

Pittsburgh by 8 over VIRGINIA TECH - Pitt has owned this series. They've won 3 straight meetings and are 14-2 ATS vs VT! However the home team is also 14-4 ATS in the series. The last five meetings in Blacksburg have gone Under the Total. It might actually benefit Pitt to get away from home after Narduzzi referred to Pittsburgh as "boo city". Both teams are off 3 straight losses but Pitt's last two came against a rejuvenated WV team and 4-0 North Carolina. QB Jurkovec was injured on the final play of the 1H and backup QB Veilleaux threw 2 int's. VT was SOD on their final drive and lost at Marshall 24-17 (+6). Pitt has really had one bad half on defense this year and Narduzzi is 30-14 ATS on the road including 14-3 as an AF so we will take the Panthers by over a td.

GEORGIA ST by 6 over Troy - As SBC foes Troy won 5 of the F/6 SU but GSt has won & covered the L/3. Last met here in '21 and GSt (-6) led 17-3 HT and 37-3 4Q before a late td made the final 37-10. GSt comes into this game 4-0 SU/ATS after beating Coastal last Th 30-17, while Troy put up 521 yds on WKU in a 27-24 win. GSt dual-threat QB Grainger is having a great ssn so far, hitting 69% (7-0) and has 263 rush (5.6) while RB Carroll has 508 yds (5.3, 8 td). Troy's offense has struggled vs better DEF's (321 vs JMU, 286 vs KSt) and they are only avg'g 77 rush ypg (2.5) vs FBS foes plus have all'd 15 sks the L/3 gms. GSt's DEF has 9 sks on the season & are holding tms to 89 rush ypg (3.0). HC Elliott has this Panthers team rolling & we have them winning & covering again here.

MARYLAND by 10 over Indiana - Maryland has won the last 2 years, but both meetings were decided by 5 pts or less. Indiana has covered 3 straight and is 6-3 ATS in the series. LTH (21) Maryland won 38-35 (-4.5) as the teams accounted for over 950 total yds and 7 of the 9 meetings have gone over the total. The Terps enter this one at 4-0 off their 31-9 (-8) win over Michigan St last week but they were actually outgained 201-166 in the 1H. MD has won all 4 games by at least 18 pts for the first time in school history. Indiana struggled to a 29-27 (-16) 4OT win over Akron. Maryland is just 2-4 ATS as a conf HF under HC Locksley and has Ohio St on deck and Indiana has played a much tougher sked (#54 vs #123), so we'll gladly take the Hoosiers getting over 2 tds here.

UCF by 8 over Baylor - Only prior meeting was the Fiesta Bowl in 2014, which UCF (+16) pulled the outright upset 52-42. UCF is off a 44-31 loss at KSt where they all'd 536 yds, while Baylor lost 38-6 vs Texas. Baylor is off to a tough start TY, but could get QB Shapen back, who threw for 303 yds in the opener before his inj. UCF is likely without QB Plumlee here after a knee inj in Week 2, but bkp QB McClain threw for 264 yds LW (58%, 3-1) & UCF is avg'g 260 rush ypg (5.9) and have all'd just 8 sks. UCF's DEF all'd just 117 rush (3.4) the F/3 wks but LW all'd 281 rush (7.0), but are all'g just 50% completions. This is BU's first road gm of '23 and UCF has a great home field edge & the crowd will be extra bouncy for their first B12 home game, but it is tough to go against BU in this spot especially as a DD dog & with their backs against the wall after a 1-3 start.

Florida by 3 over KENTUCKY - This series was once dominated by the Gators when they won 31 straight but KY has won 3 of the last 5 and are 5-0-1 ATS in the series. They outgained Utah 346-270 in their opener and beat Tenn 29-16 two weeks ago while KY has yet to play a decent team, with their only P5 win over Vandy 45-28 (-13) last week. KY is only rushing for 132 (5.5) vs a weak schedule while FL has allowed just 82 rush ypg (2.9). Napier is 15-5-1 as an underdog. Graham Mertz has settled in nicely, completing 78% w/a 4-1 ratio while KY QB Leary has thrown 5 int's and we think FL is the better team getting points here.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 10 over Virginia - BC is 6-1 SU but have only covered 2 of the last 6 meetings. UVA has covered their last two as home dogs but are 0-2 ATS playing away from home, losing 36 vs Tenn and 28 at MD. BC fell behind 28-0 2Q and 56-21 4Q vs LVille last week. They allowed 18-21-388-5-0 passing. UVA QB Colandrea has thrown for 304 ypg in his 3 starts but has a 5-6 ratio. The Cavaliers could get Tony Musket back from injury and HC Elliott has said he wouldn't lose his job due to injury so they could make a change. UVA has actually faced our #1 sked (comb'd 15-1 record) but BC has also faced a tough sked (#23) nearly upset FSU in their last home game. QB Castellanos (8-2 ratio) has sparked BC's offense and they get the call at home.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 10 over Coastal Carolina - Coastal has won 4 of the 6 gms SU as SBC foes incl the L3 & are also 4-2 ATS vs GSthrn. LY Coastal (-10) trailed 24-14 4Q but scored a td with 38 sec left to get the win 34-30. CC's offense has not been as explosive under new HC Beck, as they are avg'g just 382 ypg/20 ppg vs 3 FBS foes & 1 of their td's LW was off a muffed punt snap. GSthrn is off a 40-3 win over Ball St where QB Brin bounced back from his 5 int game vs Wisc and threw for 344 yds & 4 td's (0 int's). GSthrn is once again putting up pass yds as they are avg'g 341 pass ypg (73%). GSthrn's DEF all'd 477 & 451 yds vs their F/2 FBS foes, but held BSU to 197 yds LW and we see them limiting CC's offense & winning by DD's.

JAMES MADISON by 3 over South Alabama - First meeting. After 3 straight road games, JMU is at home where they are 6-1 SU since joining the FBS LY. JMU's pass D is all'g 371 ypg (60%) to FBS foes & SALa has a capable veteran QB in Bradley who is hitting 70% (6-3 ratio), but he could be in trouble vs a JMU pass rush that has 18 sks in 4 gms. SALa also does have a talented rush attack (179, 4.9) but JMU is all'g just 42 rush ypg (1.4). JMU did put up 512 yds and 45 pts last week and while SALa held Okla St to just 208 yds 2 wks ago, they gave up 5 td drives of 55+ yds LW to CMich and 412 yds to FCS SELA. Despite bringing back a ton of experience TY, SALa has played inconsistent football while JMU is sitting at 4-0 SU this season incl a road win over Troy and will again be out to prove they are the top team in the SBC again, but will call for this gm to finish right near the line.

MARSHALL by 20 over Old Dominion - MU has won 7 of the 8 mtgs SU and are 5-3 ATS and LY the Herd won 12-0 but still covered (-3). Last time hosting ODU, MU (-21) only won 20-13. MU is off a 24-17 win vs VA Tech where RB Ali ran for 174 yds (6.4, 2 td), while ODU survived Tex A&M Commerce, winning 10-9 (stopped late 2-pt try) and QB Wilson was benched for bkp QB Shields after throwing 3 1H int's. MU is again led by RB Ali (396, 6.3, 7 td) and MU's OLine has all'd just 2 sks on the ssn (both LW). MU's DEF has 14 sks TY & face an ODU Oline that has all'd 26 sks TY incl all'g 18 sks the last 2 wks! ODU's offense is hitting just 55% of their passes & ran for just 15 yds LW and MU pass D is all'g 159 ypg (52%) & their run D is giving up 145 (4.2). While the Herd are just 2-10 ATS as a HF under Huff, ODU's Oline issues and TO issues has us liking MU by nearly 3 td's.

Buffalo by 3 over AKRON - Bulls have won last 5 but are just 1-4 ATS (all as Fav). LTH Bulls won 45-10 as a 12' pt AF. LY Akron (+11) led 16-0 2Q but up 22-17 gave up GW td with 1:15 left to lose 23-22. These are 2 teams in a very similar situation. Both are 2-2 ATS & 0-3 SU vs FBS foes. Both struggled vs FCS foe but Akron won by 3 over a weaker team, while Buffalo lost by 3 to a '22 playoff team. Both lost LW but covered as DD road Dogs. LW Zips (+16) tied Indiana 17-17 late 4Q on a 71 yd td run but lost in 4 OT 29-27. Buffalo (+10) trailed Louisiana 31-7 late 3Q before finally playing to their potential but down just 45-38 were int'd at LA21 w/:15 left. Zips have opened as a HF, a role they are 0-2 ATS under HC Moorhead With 2 similar teams we will take the points.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 8 over Eastern Michigan - HT is 7-1 SU & 5-3 ATS. CM is 10-4 SU & ATS in series incl 3-1 L/4 LY CM off their 7th lost of ssn (no bow) lost 38-19 (E) being outgained 437-229. Both are off long road trips to Alabama, where both were the dog. EM (+7) held Jax St to 21 pts & 388 yds but despite using 3 diff QB's managed just 152 yds & were held scoreless for the first time since losing 65-0 to Florida in HC Creighton's first ssn in 2014. CM (+16) trailed S Alabama 14-0 & after two 3outs switched back to QB Bauer (started F/2) and he led the come back 34-30 upset throwing for 224 (1-0) and rushing for 55 & 4 td's incl GW w/:13 left. The Chippewas have been the better team this year and we look for them to take revenge for LY's rare loss.

Miami, Oh by 18 over KENT ST - Five of the last 6 have been outright upsets, including LY when Miami (+5) pulled out a 27-24 win (415-415 yd). The big difference this year however is Kent St lost their 5r HC & returns just 4 starters (all on Def), new QB Alaimo is avg'g just 148 ypg hitting 54% with a 1-3 ratio (-2 yd rush), Miami returns their 10 yr HC and have 16 starters back. That includes a healthy QB Gabbert who is avg'g 211 ypg hitting 61% with a 9-3 ratio (82 yd rush). Miami is off a 62-10 blowout of Delaware St as a 41' pt HF. Kent St is off a long road trip to Fresno where they were blowout 53-10 as a 27 pt AD. While Miami has a slight Def edge (#112-#126) they have a huge edge on Off (#80-#129) and should open MAC play with a comfortable win here.

Ball St by 7 over WESTERN MICHIGAN - Broncos are 6-3 SU but just 5-4 ATS as Cardinals have covered 4 of L/5. LY had 8 lead changes before WM (-6) scored a 4Q td & 2 pt conv to win 37-30. LTH Ball St (+12) pulled the 45-20 outright upset. LW The Broncos were a 21+ dog for a third straight week but finally got a cover. They shockingly led Toledo 24-14 at HT & 31-28 early 4Q before allowing final 21 to lose 49-31 as a 21 pt AD. Ball St a week after putting up 45 pts vs Indiana St the week before only managed a mid-4Q FG after trailing GSU 40-0 as a 6 pt HD. Both teams

are 1-3 and are desperate for a win, after last weeks results WM has opened as the favorite but we will lean with the more experienced Cardinals (8 yr HC- 1 yr HC, 14-10 ret starters).

MINNESOTA by 7 over Louisiana - 1st meeting since '03. Minnesota is 11-0 SU (7-3 ATS) vs Sun Belt teams. Louisiana is 1-3 SU & 2-2 ATS vs P5 teams since '19 and did upset Iowa St (31-14, +11) in 2020. The Cajuns outgained Buffalo 518-373 in their 45-38 (-10) home win last weekend and are now averaging 480 ypg, including going over 500 total yds the last 2 games. Minny was upset 37-34 (-11) by Northwestern last week and have allowed 506 ypg the last 2 weeks. The Gophers have yet to put together a full game offensively and the Cajuns seem to have found a groove the last 2 weeks, so we'll ride with the visiting team getting double-digits.

MASSACHUSETTS by 3 over Arkansas St - Only prior meeting was last season where Ark St (-17) was outgained by 200 yds & UMass had a 25-11 FD edge but Ark St got a pick-6 and UMass was SOD twice. After winning their opener, UMass has lost 4 straight & LW despite being +167 yds they lost to NMex 34-31 in OT. Ark St is allowing teams to throw for 70% TY and UMass QB Davis has throw for 886 yds (61%), but left in the 2H LW & was replaced by Ahmad Haston. Ark St's offense only 438 total yds vs their F/2 FBS foes (OU, Memp), but put up 425 yds & 44 pts LW vs SMiss and the UMass defense has all'd foes to gain 66 ypg above their avg. However Ark St has Troy on deck and we see UMass pulling out a close win.

WYOMING by 10 over New Mexico - WY has won 4 of the L/6 mtgs SU but have failed to cover 3 of the L/4 gms. LY WY (-3) was actually outgained by NMex, but were +3 TO's and won 27-14. WY is off a 22-19 home win vs App St where they were -209 yds & -20 FD's but ret'd a blocked FG for a td with under 2 min left 4Q and pulled out a 22-19 win. NMex went to UMass LW and got a 34-31 OT win despite being -167 yds. WY has ran for 168 ypg (4.6) vs FBS foes & NMex is all'g 169 rush ypg (4.9) vs FBS foes. NMex is showing more on offense TY avg'g 385 ypg/29 ppg. NMex is just 2-10-1 as a DD MW dog the L/2Y, but WY is 0-3 ATS since '21 as a DD MW favorite and they do have a key MW home game vs Fresno on deck and are laying 2 td's here.

Usc by 24 over COLORADO - "Big Noon Kickoff" (10am Boulder time) lost some of its luster LW following the Buffs 36 pt loss in Eugene to the Ducks who finished with 30-13 FD and 522-199 yd edges. They now play host to a Trojans squad that they've NEVER beaten as USC holds a 16-0 mark all-time (8-4 ATS run w/18 pt MOV). The Trojans (-34) stumbled through the 1H of their 42-28 win over ASU although QB Williams threw for 322 yds and 5 tl TD's (USC 535-353 yd edge). We like the Trojans in this one as they've covered 7 of their L/11 as away chalk heading in while CU is just 2-8 ATS vs the P12 and saw their "Hype Bubble" burst a week ago.

UNLV by 7 over Hawaii - UH has won 4 of the L/5 mtgs SU. LY UH (+11) trailed 13-7 HT but outscored UNLV 24-12 in the 2H and won 31-25. UNLV is off to a 3-1 start & LW beat UTEP 45-28 behind 4 td's from RB Thomas while UH got a GW FG on the final play LW to beat NMSt. UH is only avg'g 333 yds on offense & are getting held to 61 rush ypg (2.4) and the Oline has all'd 19 sacks (9.0%). However, UH's pass attack is avg'g 272 ypg and they are facing a UNLV pass D that has all'd 292 ypg vs FBS foes & overall UNLV is all'g 411 ypg. UH all'd 560 yds to Oregon, but in their other 4 gms all'd 319 ypg. UNLV started QB Maiava LW (Brumfield hurt) but Brumfield could be back here. UH was 3-1 ATS as an AD in MW play while UNLV was 0-2 ATS as a MW HF LY and we like UH to keep this one within the line.

CALIFORNIA by 17 over Arizona St - Both teams head into this matchup following rough Pac-12 openers as the Sun Devils were handed a 14 pt defeat last week in Tempe (USC 535-353 yd edge) while the Bears all'd 45 pts in the 1H to UW in the eventual 59-32 defeat (most pts Cal has ever surrendered in a half!). After winning 4 straight from '08-'11, Cal has dropped 3 of the past 4 against ASU with the most recent meeting coming back in '19 where the Sun Devils (+4) pulled the 24-17 road upset against a #15 ranked Bears squad. Not only has ASU done well in this series but they've also had success when listed as an AD with a solid 9-4 ATS mark. Although Cal 4-11-1 as a home favorite, we're extremely concerned about the vast amount of injury issues on ASU as they head to the road for the 1st time this year.

Oregon by 34 over STANFORD - Following a 1 pt home defeat LW against Arizona where they finished with a narrow yardage edge and led going into the 4Q, the Cardinal are back on "The Farm" for a 2nd straight week to take on a Ducks squad that hammered Colorado LW in Autzen (led 42-0 after 3Q's, 30-13 FD & 522-199 yd edges). The HT has won and covered each of the L/3Y including a 45-27 (-17) win by Oregon LY in Eugene where they had a 515-332 yard edge. Despite Stanford's win in '21, they've had their share of struggles as a HD with just a 3-7 mark. With the Ducks 7-3 ATS the L/2Y vs P12 foes, a commanding victory should be expected in this one.

Washington by 21 over ARIZONA - After a 1 pt win last week at Stanford where QB de Laura left in the 3Q with injury (bkp Fifita 4-4-47-0-0), the Wildcats return to the desert having covered each of the 1st 4 contests on the year. They now welcome an undefeated Huskies squad that picked up a 27 pt win LW in Seattle (QB Penix 304 pass yds, 4 TD, UW 40+ pts for 4th consec gm was 1st time s/1944). In their Seattle meeting a year ago, the Huskies (-14') led by just a FG mid 4Q before a late TD gave them a 49-39 victory. Arizona is on a 10-3 ATS run but Washington has looked like a juggernaut on offense and Arizona won't be able to keep up if de Laura can't play. Washington is also on a 7-0-1 ATS run.

South Carolina (+) over TENNESSEE - The Vols had their season wrecked by SC last year when they entered #1 but QB Rattler lit the Vols up for 438 yards and 6 td passes as SC won 63-38 as 22 pt dogs. Rattler has a 17-5 ratio since that game. SC got the call as our 5★ Sept GOM last week and the Gamecocks came through 37-30 (-6) as Rattler hit 18 of 20 passes for 288 yds and 3 td's! Tenn was our 4★ Top play on these pages LW (-24) and were covering at half, up 31-0 and won 45-14! The underdog is 10-3 ATS in this series and we've been impressed with SC who led UGA at half 2 weeks ago and obviously came through LW. Beamer's team turned a corner against the Vols last year and Rattler is hitting 74% while Tenn is allowing 69% and SC also has Xavier Legette who leads the FBS with 556 rec yds! We are going back to SC but this time as our Underdog POW!

FRESNO ST by 31 over Nevada - Fresno has won 4 of the L/6 games vs Nev SU and LY the Bulldogs (-22) were up 24-0 HT (+196 yds) and went on to win 41-14 (+3 TO's). Fresno is off to a 4-0 start and have two P5 win under their belt, while Nevada is struggling, as the offense is avg'g just 311 ypg/17 ppg and LW 2 of their td's were on a pick-6 and a fumble ret td. Nev's defense is giving up 537 ypg/41 ppg and their pass D is allowing 341 ypg (73% completions). Fresno's QB Keene should have a good day here as he is hitting 68% (12-2 ratio) and the offense is avg'g 429 ypg. The Bulldogs defense is all g just 298 ypg and giving up just 54% completions and 103 rush ypg (3.1). Nev is just 2-5 ATS as a dog of 20+ pts the L2Y while Fresno is 4-2 ATS as a 20+ point favorite under Tedford. We expect the Bulldogs to win here by over 4 td's.

NAVY by 7 over USF - 1st meeting since 2019. Navy is off a bye and enters at 1-2 SU/ATS with their lone win over FCS Wagner. They lost 28-24 (+13) at Memphis 2 weeks ago in a game that was tied at HT. The Middies did show signs of life on offense as they rushed for 299 (6.0) and topped 400 yds via an FBS foe for the 1st time since week 6 of last year. USF opened AAC play with a 42-29 (+2) home win over Rice in which the Bulls put up 597 yards, including 435 passing by QB Byrum Brown (22-29, 2-0 ratio). Navy is just 5-12 SU & 7-10 ATS at home since '20, so that has us leaning with a USF squad that is getting more than a fg.

Illinois by 4 over PURDUE - Purdue has won 6 of the last 7, including a 31-24 (+14) upset win last year over #24 Illinois that helped propel the Boilermakers into the B10 Championship game, while also knocking Illinois out of contention. Purdue (1-3 SU/ATS) is off a 38-17 (-5) home loss to Wisconsin on Friday night. The Boilermakers finished with a slight yardage edge, but were never really in the game after getting down 14 in the 1Q. Illinois beat non-conf foe FAU 23-17 (-15) which moved the Illini to 2-2, but they have yet to cover this year. Their defense has not been dominant like last year's squad, but have held their last 2 opponents under 400 yards. The Illini will certainly remember last year's loss and will look to exact some revenge and we think they escape with a win and cover the line that is under a fg.

TOLEDO by 10 over Northern Illinois - Winner has won the MAC Chmp the L/2 yrs. Visitor has won & covered 4 straight, NIU is 9-4 SU & 7-5-1 ATS in series s/10, LTH NIU kicked GW Fg w/26 left to win 22-20 as a 12 pt AD. LY Toledo (-7) led 45-7 but only won 52-32. The last 2 weeks the Favored Rockets have trailed in the 3Q and while they have 2 come from behind wins they failed to cover either. Since NIU upset BC in their opener, they have lost 3 straight SU & ATS(2 as Fav). A big part of that QB Lombardi who after missing most of LY with injury, has not returned to his '21 form when he led NIU to the MAC Championship. He is avg 141 ypg (51%) with a poor 1-4 ratio (-30 rush). UT has failed to cover 2 straight and might not have QB Finn who left with an injury last week.

Alabama by 17 over MISSISSIPPI ST - This is a one-sided series. Bama is 9-1 SU/6-4 ATS in Starkville and MSU has lost 15 straight meetings (4-11 ATS). Miss St has been held under 300 yards in 18 of the last 21 meetings. Bama's offense still hasn't matched their potential but the defense stood tall last week in their 24-10 (-7) win over Ole Miss. We won our 5★ Sept GOM going against Miss St last week! QB Rogers did throw for a career high 487 yards after being held under 200 pass yds in each of the two previous games. Miss St allowed 4 sacks in each of the L2W and has to deal a far more talented front 7 for Bama led by OLB Dallas Turner (4.5 sks). Bama is 1-8 as an AF but Miss St is 1-8 as a HD. We can't help but go with series history but need to see more from Bama's offense before we give them a big lean.

OKLAHOMA by 16 over Iowa ST - OU has won and covered the L/2 mtgs vs ISU after failing to cover 5 of 6 meetings between '16-'20. LY OU (-1) was held to just 332 yds & 27 pts in a 14 pt win in Ames. OU is off to a 4-0 start led by the offense (507 ypg) and QB Gabriel who is hitting 78% (12-1 ratio). OU has also been strong on D, all g just 311 ypg/9 ppg. ISU got their first win LW vs Okla St & put up 422 yds/34 pts but their 18 gm streak of all g under 400 yds was snapped, but their D is all g just 293 ypg/17 ppg on the season. OU has failed to cover the L/4 games before Texas and while ISU's defense will keep them around in this game & Campbell is 9-5-1 ATS as an AD in Big 12 play and is an even better 9-2 ATS as a DD underdog in B12 play.

Georgia by 18 over AUBURN - UGA has owned this series, going 5-0 SU/ATS and they've won 15 of the last 18 (14-4 ATS). Georgia is now 0-3-1 ATS on the season after only beating UAB 49-21 (-40). The Dawgs did put up a season high 582 yards but also allowed a ssn high 336 and 21 pts with 14 coming in the 1H. Auburn was outgained 402-200 yard edge in a 27-10 (-9) loss. QB Thorne threw for just 44 yards and was replaced. Auburn's only td came on a 67 yd fumble return. HC Smart is 19-8 as an AF but HC Freeze is 9-4 as a HD. Auburn put up 527 ypg at home but against two very weak foes and we think it's time for UGA to put together a full performance so we call for the Dawgs to win by over 2 td's.

MEMPHIS by 6 over Boise ST - First meeting. Memphis is off their 1st loss of the season vs Mizzou 34-27 where they all'd 542 yds, while Boise hung on to beat SDSt on the road last Fri despite being -36 yds & -3 FD's (+2 TO's). Boise's run game came to life LW despite not having RB Holani, as bkp RB Jeanty ran for 205 yds (8.9) and 2 td and the Tigers run D has all'd 250 rush ypg (5.8) the L/2 gms (67%). However, Boise's D is an issue as they are all g 512 ypg to FBS foes TY incl 345 pass ypg and Memp is throwing for 279 ypg led by QB Henigan (69%). Memp is on a 25-1 SU/16-10 ATS run at home vs non-conf foes and Boise has their MW home opener on deck, so we'll take the Tigers by just under a td.

Appalachian ST by 8 over ULM - As SBC foes App St has won 6 of 7 gms SU but are just 3-4 ATS. Last met here in '20 where App St (-31) led 21-7 HT and 31-7 into 4Q before a ULM td on the final play 4Q made it 31-13. App St is off a tough road loss at WY where they were +209 yds but lost 22-19 on a blk'd fg return for td by WY late 4Q. ULM is off a bye and enters here 2-1 and they are led by a solid rush attack (206, 6.0) but are only avg'g 95 pass ypg! ULM's D is giving up just 384 ypg, but are all g foes to hit 73%. App St is led by QB Aguilar (58%, 9-3) and a run game avg'g 203 ypg (4.4), but ULM is all g just 152 rush ypg (3.8). ULM enters 6-2 ATS as a HD under HC Bowden with 5 outright upsets and App St went 0-4 ATS as an SBC AF last season.

Texas St by 3 over SOUTHERN MISS - 4th mtg, home tm is 0-3 SU/ATS. Met LY and SMiss (-2) held TXST to 243 yds and won 20-14. SMiss fell to 1-3 TY after losing LW at Ark St 44-37, as they all'd 425 yds but did get their run gm going (234, 6.9) for the 1st time this ssn. Despite TXST being +221 yds LW vs Nev (574-353) they only won 35-24 and trailed 17-0 2Q after giving up a pick-6 and a fumble ret td. While SMiss is only all'g 187 pass ypg (53%) they have given up 202 rush ypg (5.5) and TXST has gotten their run gm going the L/2 gms (338 ypg/9.0 ypc!) led by RB Mahdi. We see TXST getting the win & but it is tough to lean with them here giving over a td on the road.

Lsu by 5 over MISSISSIPPI - The visitor in this series is just 2-8 SU/1-9 ATS but Ole Miss is only 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS. We cashed a 2★ on these pages going against LSU last week. The Tigers were -17' but needed a fg with :05 to beat Ark 34-31 but they did crush Miss St 41-14 in Starkville 2 weeks ago. Ole Miss led Bama 7-6 at half but lost 24-10 (+7). RB Judkins led the SEC in rushing LY but has just 201 this year and his ypc has dropped from 5.7 to 3.5. LSU is allowing just 122 rush ypg (4.0) vs FBS foes. QB Daniels has picked up where he left off, with a 12-2 ratio. LSU won 45-20 last year but only had a 500-404 yd edge in a misleading final and while we expect this to be much closer, the Tigers still get the edge with the better defense.

Missouri by 8 over VANDERBILT - Vandy has lost the L/3 meetings but covered 4 of the last 5, all as at least 14 pt dogs. Mizzou was off a huge win over Kansas St and didn't falter LW vs Memphis, winning 34-27 (-7) w/a 542-399 yd edge. WR Burden is #4 in the FBS with 504 yards (15.8) and QB Cook has a 7-0 ratio. Vandy has lost 3 straight after falling LW to KY 45-28 though they only were outgained 365-328 and had a +1 FD edge. With Missouri off two big wins they are in a flat spot, especially with LSU on deck while this is the one SEC team that Vandy might have a home crowd edge against. Mizzou has also lost 8 straight road openers (3-5 ATS) so we will take the pts here.

SMU by 28 over Charlotte - 1st ever meeting and the AAC debut for Charlotte and both teams have a bye on deck. Charlotte (1-3 SU, 2-2 ATS) was held to just 210 total yds in their 22-7 (+28) loss to Florida last week and are averaging 306 total ypg on the year. The Mustangs (2-2 SU/ATS) are off a 34-17 (+7) loss at TCU. SMU only trailed 14-10 at HT, but allowed 13 pts in the 3Q and could never get closer than 10 the rest of the way. SMU is off a tough but the bye next week should allow them to remain focused here and we think they have too much talent on both sides of the ball for a Charlotte team that has yet to find its stride offensively under their new coach.

† Texas A&M by 10 over Arkansas - Arlington. A&M has won 10 of the last 11 meetings including LY 23-21. Ark did cover the four previous meetings, although 3 of those were as double-digit dogs. The Aggies are off a 27-10 win (-8) where they didn't allow an offensive td and backup QB Max Johnson threw 2 td passes after Connor Weigman was inj'd. Ark outgained BYU 424-281 two weeks ago but lost 38-31. LW they were +17' and nearly upset LSU on the road. The Hogs have battled injuries themselves with RB Rocket Sanders not playing since the opener and they've had numerous players including OL and CB's miss action. We love that A&M has held 3 of their four foes to less than 225 yds and they've played the tougher sked (#42 vs #82). Gig em!

TEXAS by 13 over Kansas - Since '16 Texas is 4-2 SU against KU but have gone just 1-5 ATS. LY Texas was only a single-digit dog for the first time since 1997 and they got revenge on KU for the upset in '21, winning 55-14 (+193 yds). KU is off to a 4-0 start for the 2nd straight ssn, which has not happened in over 100 yrs (1913-1915) as they beat BYU 38-27 (+3 TO's) with the help of 2 DEF td's. Texas opened B12 play with a 38-6 win vs Baylor (+138 yds). KU is just 3-6 ATS under Leipold as a B12 AD but Texas is 0-2 ATS under Sark as a DD Big 12 favorite and they do have their rival OU on deck, plus KU's defense is stepping up more this ssn, as they are all'g just 297 ypg, incl all'g only 93 rush ypg (3.3). While Tex is the best team KU has faced, we see them hanging around in this one.

RICE by 1 over East Carolina - 1st meeting since 2010. The Owls enter this one off a 42-29 (-2) road loss to USF last week that moved them to 2-2 (3-1 ATS). The Owls were outgained 597 and are now allowing 499 ypg yp FBS foes. West Virginia transfer QB JT Daniels leads an offense that is avg 44 ppg and 482 ypg the last 3 weeks. ECU got their first win last week with a 44-0 home victory over FCS foe Gardner-Webb. The Pirates have alternated QB's most of the year and Alex Flinn and Mason Garcia combined to go 17-30 for 183 in the win. Rice is just 1-5 ATS as a conf HF since 2018 and ECU is 8-3 as a conf AD dog under HC Houston and we think Pirates can do just enough on offense to keep this one within the line.

TCU by 7 over West Virginia - From 2016-21 WVU won 5 of 6 mtgs SU and covered all 6 gms incl pulling a pair of upsets in '19 and '21. LY TCU (-7) led 28-21 at HT and only led by 4 late 4Q until a td with 20 sec left gave them the cover (41-31 win). TCU is off a 34-17 win vs SMU, while WVU is off an upset win vs TT at home. WVU QB Greene missed LW (ankle) and true fro bkp Marchiol got the start but was just 12-21 for 78 yds & a 1-2 ratio. TCU's D did allow 416 yds LW but were +2 TO's and they are all'g 293 pass ypg. While TCU's pass rush has 16 sks, they face a WVU OL that has all'd just 7 sks TY and are helping pave the way for 190 rush ypg (4.2). TCU's offense remains strong (501 ypg/38 ppg) and we think that is the diff here & have them by a td.

AIR FORCE by 16 over San Diego St - From 2010-21 SDSt won all 9 mtgs SU and were 7-2 ATS vs AF. Last season AF (-2) led 7-0 HT and held SDSt to 187 yds in a 13-3 win. LW AF trailed 20-10 1H vs SJSt but shut them out 2H and pulled away to win 45-20 as both TB Michel and FB Eldridge topped 100 yds. SDSt lost last Fri to Boise at home 34-31 despite having the yds edge (-2 TO's, missed FG). QB Mayden threw for 241 & ran for 85 yds but limped off the field late 4Q (check status). SDSt's run D has all'd 229 ypg (6.1) the L/3 gms & AF is the #1 rush attack (341, 5.4). If Mayden cant go here SDSt's QB depth lacks exp and we see AF winning by over 2 td's.

2★ Miami over BUFFALO - The Dolphins are on the road for the 3rd time over the 1st 4 weeks as they head North following a 50 pt home win against the Broncos where they became just the 5th team since 1970 to record 4 rush and 4 rec TD's in a single game (70 pts & 726 yds!). The Bills meanwhile picked up an easy 37-3 road victory LW in D.C. (BUF 386-230 yd edge). The Bills have dominated the recent series with wins in 9 of the L/10 (5-5 ATS) including a 34-31 (-13) home victory in LY's WC Rnd where they finished with 25-16 FD and 423-231 yd edges. The Dolphins (7-1 ATS vs AFC East foes) do however get a lucky break of traveling to Orchard Park early in the ssn before the winter weather begins. **FORECAST: Miami by 7**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Tampa Bay over NEW ORLEANS - The Saints are inside of the Superdome for the only time in a 5-week span following a 2-game road trip that saw them get past the Panthers on MNF and blow a 17-0 lead in the 4Q against the Packers (trips to NE & HOU on deck). The Bucs meanwhile head into the "Big Easy" on short rest after a MNF home meeting against the Eagles. The Bucs picked up the series sweep against the Saints LY (1-1 ATS) including a 20-10 (-2) road victory (NO 5 TO's). With that impressive feat and the Saints failing to cover 5 of 6 against DIV foes in '22, we're leaning in favor of the visiting team in this one as the Saints will likely be without QB Carr in this one (left LW w/shldr inj). **FORECAST: Tampa Bay by 8**

OTHER PLAYS

Detroit at GREEN BAY - Thursday - The Lions were able to get back on track LW at home against the Falcons with a 358-183 yd edge in the 20-6 victory. They now head North to take on a Packers squad that overcame a 17-0 deficit in the 4Q against the Saints in the 1 point victory (QB Love 298 tll yds & 2 TD's). The Lions have grabbed victories in 3 straight (SU & ATS) against the Packers including LY's ssn finale in Lambeau (+5). While DET has also gone 10-0 ATS inside of the NFC North (9 pt avg cover), the last time GB didn't cover as a HD was way back in '17. We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.

Atlanta by 3 over Jacksonville - London. This marks the 1st of 2 consecutive games in England for the Jags as they head across the pond following a surprising 37-17 home loss against the Texans (JAX -2 TO's and all'd KR TD). This is the 10th all-time game for the Jags in their home away from home as they own a 4-5 SU and ATS mark that includes a narrow 21-17 (-1) loss LY to DEN. The Falcons (1-1 SU/2-2 ATS in London) tasted defeat for the 1st time LW in DET as they were held to just 6 pts and 183 yards in a 14 pt defeat. ATL has won and covered their L/4 meetings (s/'11) against the Jags with a 13 pt avg MOV. With JAX also going just 2-8 ATS as a recent favorite and failing to cover 32 of their L/39 against the AFC, we'll call for the Falcons to get the outright upset here (ATL 7-3-1 ATS as a dog).

Minnesota by 6 over CAROLINA - The Panthers are at home for the only time in a 4-week span following a loss in SEA where bkp QB Dalton threw for 361 yds and 2 TD's for the injured Bryce Young (road trips to DET & MIA on deck). The Vikings meanwhile moved to 0-3 on the year after a pair of failed TD drives late in the game trailing 28-24 (QB Cousins 32-50-367-3-1). The Panthers have dropped 4 of the L/5 (2-3 ATS) against the Vikings including a 34-28 OT road loss (+2) in '21 where they were outgained 571-306 (MIN QB Cousins 33-48-373-3-0). While CAR has gone a solid 5-1-1 ATS as a HD, we expect the Vikings to get the job done here as they've gone 9-4-1 ATS as a NDIV AF.

CHICAGO by 3 over Denver - The Bears are at home for the only time in a 4-week span following a pair of road losses to TB (outgained 437-236 in 10 pt defeat) and KC (outgained 456-203 in 31 pt defeat). The Broncos meanwhile are also sitting at 0-3 after a 70-20 defeat LW in "South Beach" where the Dolphins gashed them for 376 pass and 350 rush yds (2nd most yds all'd in NFL history!). The all-time series between these 2 is split at 8 apiece with the Bears picking up the win in the most recent outing (16-14 victory in '19, L/4 decided by 3 pts or less incl 2 OT gms!). With CHI also going 8-4-1 ATS against the AFC, backing the Broncos could be a costly mistake after LW's effort.

Pittsburgh by 1 over HOUSTON - After a shocking DIV road win LW against the Jags (-7) where rookie QB Stroud had another strong performance (664 pass yds & 4-0 ratio L2W), the Texans return home to take on a Steelers squad making their 2nd straight road trip following a 5 pt win in LV where they took advantage of a 3 TO's by the Raiders (LV 362-333 yd edge). The Steelers own a 5-2 all-time edge in this series including 3 consecutive wins (SU & ATS). The most recent matchup was in '20 where PIT (-4) finished with 25-13 FD and 387-260 yd edges in the 7 pt victory. While the Steelers have covered 8 of their past 10 contests overall, they've clearly struggled when laying points with just a 3-7 ATS mark.

INDIANAPOLIS by 3 over LA Rams - The Rams return to action on short rest following a MNF trip to CIN. They're now back on the road to take on a Colts squad that picked up an OT upset LW in BAL with bkp Minshew throwing for 227 yds and a TD in the 22-19 victory. The Colts have dropped 3 in a row to the Rams (1-2 ATS) including a 27-24 (+3) home defeat in '21 (GW 38-yd FG w/2:23 left). They have however gone 10-5 ATS in meetings with the NFC which has us leaning in their direction in this one as LA has failed to cover 12 of their past 16 contests when facing the AFC.

PHILADELPHIA by 4 over Washington - The Eagles return home on short rest following a MNF trip to Tampa to take on the Bucs. WAS meanwhile takes the short trip to Philly after suffering their 1st loss of the ssn LW at home against the Bills who held WAS to just 3 pts and 230 yds in the 34 pt victory (QB Howell 4 int's!). Following a 9-0 beginning LY, the Commanders (+11) surprisingly halted the Eagles undefeated run on MNF finishing with 25-18 FD and 330-264 yard edges. While PHI has had quite a bit of success as a HF coming in with a 10-4 ATS mark, laying too many points in their direction could prove costly as they've failed to cover 12 of their L/18 inside of the NFC East.

Cincinnati by 4 over TENNESSEE - The Bengals are sitting at 0-2 as of presstime with a key MNF meeting at home with the Rams where they look to turn things around. They now head South to take on a Titans squad that was held to just 6 FD's and 94 tll yards in a 27-3 defeat against the Browns (3.5★ LP Winner on Under 38.5!). The Bengals have won 3 straight in the series (SU & ATS) including LY's trip to Nashville where they finished with 21-15 FD and 374-344 yard edges. If Joe Burrow is ready to go (? on MNF vs LAR w/caif), we expect that trend to continue here as CIN has also covered 11 of 12 meetings against NDIV foes.

LA CHARGERS by 3 over Las Vegas - Following a 5 pt home loss to the Steelers where QB Garoppolo threw a trio of int's, the Raiders are back on the road for the 3rd time in 4 weeks to take on a Chargers squad that held on for a 4 pt win LW in MIN with QB Herbert throwing for 405 yds and 3 TD's (WR Allen 18 rec & 215 yds). The home team has won each of the past 4 games (SU & ATS) in this series with a 7 pt avg MOV. The Raiders are however 7-2 ATS against DIV foes while also picking up covers in 10 of their L/15 as an AD. With the Chargers going just 1-8 ATS prior to their bye week, we're cutting off their lean at a FG.

DALLAS by 10 over New England - The Cowboys had looked dominant in their 1st 2 matchups of the ssn before laying an egg in a shocking 28-16 loss LW in the desert as a 13 pt favorite against the Cardinals. The Patriots meanwhile earned their 1st win of the ssn LW against the Jets (15th straight win over NYJ) with a 358-171 yard edge. After dropping 7 straight to start this series (1971-1996), the Patriots went on to win the next 6 (1999-2019) before the most recent matchup that took place in '21. In that meeting, the Cowboys (-3) got a GW 35-yd TD pass in OT for the 35-29 victory (DAL 32-17 FD & 567-335 yd edges). While newly added Zeke Elliott would love to take out his former squad (RB w/DAL from '16-'22), the Patriots have gone 2-10 ATS as a dog while failing to cover 8 of their L/10 overall (Cowboys 11-5 ATS as a HF).

SAN FRANCISCO by 18 over Arizona - The 49ers open as a lopsided favorite in this one following a 3-0 start and extra rest after an 18 pt Thur night victory over the Giants where they finished with 26-10 FD and 441-150 yd edges (nearly doubled NYG's possession time). The Cardinals meanwhile are a perfect 3-0 ATS after picking up their 1st win of the ssn LW in the desert against the Cowboys as nearly a 2 TD HD. The 49ers picked up the sweep with relative ease a year ago outscoring the Cardinals by a combined 76-23 (ARZ held to just 255 yds in Wk 18 defeat). With ARZ failing to cover 7 of their L/8 inside of the NFC West and SF going 11-1 ATS as home chalk, it may be a long afternoon for the visitor in this one.

Kansas City at NY JETS - SNF - The Jets are at home for the 3rd time in 4 weeks following a 5 pt defeat against the Patriots LW where they were held to just 171 yards. The Chiefs meanwhile picked up an easy 31 pt win LW in Arrowhead against the Bears with 31-11 FD and 456-203 yd edges. In their most recent meeting back in '20, the Chiefs (-20) got a 416 yard, 5 TD game from Patrick Mahomes in the 35-9 victory. While the Jets have failed to cover 7 of their past 8 overall, keep in mind that they did pull the outright upset of the Bills back in Wk 1 with Zach Wilson under center for nearly the entire contest. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Seattle at NY GIANTS - MNF - This marks the only HG in a 5-week span for the Giants as they return to MetLife after splitting their West Coast trip at ARZ (3 pt win, trailed 20-0 at HT) and SF (26-10 FD & 441-150 yd deficits in 18 pt loss) with trips to MIA and BUF on deck. The Seahawks (4★ Newsletter & 3★ LP Winner vs CAR) have gone 9-3 ATS following a bye dating back to '11 which ironically was an 11 pt victory in NY as a 9' point dog. The Seahawks have won 5 of the L/6 (SU & ATS) including a 27-13 (-3) home win LY where they held the Giants to just 14 FD's and 225 yards. SEA has however failed to cover 8 of their L/11 overall while the Giants are 9-4 ATS in recent contests as a dog.
