Cal gave up 467 yds and only beat FCS Sac St 42-30 (-24'). The Bears normally stout Bears D is allowing 446 ypg and they are -11 ypg. UW is allowing 296 ypg and the Huskies are +115 ypg. The Huskies 0-2 start was concerning but their big win last week gives them confidence and this is their P12 opener so they have plenty to play for. Cal is 9-1 as an AD but the line is only -7' and after UW's slow start and we've got the Huskies by more than 2 td's.

A&M got their offense going early against New Mex and led 24-0 at half. They finished w/a 429-122 yd edge and QB Calzada did threw for 275 and 3 td's after he struggled the wk prior. The Aggies have allowed just 17 pts and 239 ypg. Ark is +227 ypg and all 3 wins have come by 19 pts or more. Toledo off an almost upset of Notre Dame as a 17 pt AD had a late loss hangover as after putting up 29 vs ND were only able to put up 6 vs Colorado St a tm that had allowed 42 to FCS South Dakota St. They held CS to 5 FG's but allowed a 70 yd PR td that put the Rams up 13-6 late 3Q & allowed three 4Q FG's to lose 22-6 as a 14' pt HF. UT is 7-4 SU in series but 4-7 ATS losing the L/2 SU & ATS. LY Ball St led 17-3 at HT & 27-9 early 4Q but needed a strip sack of UT at BSU 40 to hold onto a 27-24 win as a 10 pt AD. MARYLAND by 11 over Kent State - 1st ever meeting. Maryland has been impressive this ssn, off to their first 3-0 start since '16. Taulia Tagovailoa has provided stability for the Terrapins, and has simply been masterful (956, 76%, 7/0 in 3 gms), averaging 9 yds per attempt while 2nd in completions and 3rd in yds in the nation. "Tua's brother" is now a darkhorse Heisman candidate. Kent St has been tested early this ssn w/ two top-6 tms on the road, vs. Texas A&M (+17') and lowa (+22'), going 0-2 ATS. COASTAL CAROLINA by 30 over Massachusetts - Met 3 x from '17 to '19 with the CCU going 3-1 SU & ATS (dog F/2). In '19 CCU led just 21-14 2Q before pulling away w/3 td in L/4:40 of 1H cruising to a 62-28 win as a 16' pt AF with their FBS high 636 yds. LTH was CCU's first as an FBS tm. They never trailed (won 38-28) as a 2' pt HD but game was tied 3x. After covering as a fav of 35 (Cit) & 26' (Kan), CCU only beat Buffalo 28-25 as a 14 pt AD. While they are putting up 452 ypg vs FBS foes they are in turn allowing 409 ypg.. CCU is avg 230 ypg rush (6.0), while UMass is allowing 219 ypg rush (5.2) but UMass is avg 4.1 ypc while CCU is allowing 4.7. UMass has played a much tougher schedule (#19-#113) & has covered 2 straight with 28 pts in each incl against BC & should keep it under the big line here, with CCU having their SBC opener on deck.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN by 13 over Fiu- First mtg. The Panthers have now lost 8 straight road games after their 54-21 (+20') loss at Texas Tech. FIU did have a 7-0 lead and were only down 38-21 when TT pulled away late but they were out FD'd 31-10. CMich (+19') has only faced an FCS foe and 2 SEC foes, covering in their opener against Mizzou but they were no match for LSU last week, falling behind 42-7 3Q. Both teams feature Power 5 transfer QB's. The Chips are actually 7-2 SU/8-1 ATS at home including 4-0 as a HF while FIU has lost their last 8 road games by 20 ppg. A key in this gm for OSU will be to keep everyone healthy and Akron QB DJ Irons has been impressive, including completing all 13 passes he threw vs Auburn. The Buckeyes will explore their depth in this gm. We expect OSU rolls by 7 scores in The Shoe but our lean is with the Zips.

GS got QB Tomlin back last week but the Eagles have ran for just 146 ypg (4.0) vs FBS foesand face a LA run D that has all'd 145 ypg (4.1) in the F/3 gms. LA has been known for their run gm under HC Napier but this ssn were avg'g just 95 ypg (3.2) the F/2 gms but ran for 310 (6.3) last week. LA is also throwing for 279 ypg and the GSthrn pass D is giving up 354 ypg (61%), but the GSthrn D has collected 8 sks in 3 gms. We feel like LA's offense is finally clicking, but GSthrn

is 4-2 ATS s/18 as a home dog and should keep this gm within 2 TD's. **Boise St by 14 over UTAH ST** - Boise St is 17-1 SU against USU dating back to 1'98 & the lone win for USU came in 15. DUKE by 11 over Kansas - This is a matchup better suited for the basketball court, but on the football field these tms have met 2 times in '09 (KU win 44-16) and '14 (Duke win 41-3) with the home tm winning both times. KU is off a 45-7 loss to Baylor while Duke is off a 30-23 win against N'Western. Duke has run for 280 ypg (5.9) against 2 FBS foes this ssn & KU has all'd 229 rush ypg (5.5) to FBS foes this ssn incl all'g 307 (6.8) last wk to Baylor. Duke is putting up 236 ypg more than what their foes typically allow & LW threw for 350 and now face a KU pass D that is all'g 80% completions to FBS tms. KU is putting up just 274 ypg and have given up 7 sks in 3 gms, but Duke's pass rush has only 3 sks on 90 pass att faced. While KU is on a 3-13 ATS slide dating back to '19 we don't think Duke is over 2 td's better than KU & see them win here by just over a TD.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 5 over Missouri - First meeting. Last week BC lost QB Jurkovec for the season prior to playing Temple. The line dropped and we liked their bkp QB Grosel, who has experience, so we still used BC in their 28-3 (-14'), giving us a 4 ★ LPS winner! We also won a 4 ★ LPS going against Mizzou 2 wks ago in their 35-28 (+5') loss at KY. The Tigers bounced back last week, beating SEMO 59-28, and had a 45-0 lead 3Q. BC is +151 ypg but they've played an extremely light sked so far. The Tigers allowed 294 rush last week but almost all of that came in the 2H but the week prior they gave up 332 rush (6.4) vs KY. BC RB Garwo has 238 (6.8) and while their offense only put up 221 yds last week, that was largely because they sat on a 21-0 lead in the 2H. We like

the Eagles to continue their hot start and win by more than a fg. NORTHWESTERN over Ohio by 11 - LW Louisiana scored 3 TDs on 4th down and the Bobcats trailed just 14-7 before the final play of the 1H, eventually falling to a vengeful Ragun Cajuns 49-14 (+20). IU still led 21-17 but their last 3 possessions were fumble/int/SOD and the Hoosiers lost 38-24 but did finish with a +61 yd edge. WKU is fresh off a bye and ply'g in front of a home crowd vs a P5 foe for the first time since 2016 when they nearly upset Vandy as an 8 pt dog. Toppers QB Bailey Zappe has a 10-2 ratio and prior to their bye he threw for 435 vs Army in a 3 pt loss. Indiana has allowed just 54% and 184 pass ypg. We would like the situation better for WKU if Indiana lost and the Toppers were down 21 in the 4Q of their loss to Army. We like an angry Indiana team to win by almost 2 td's.

AIR FORCE by 7 over Fau - Only met 1 time prior & that was back in '18 when AF (+9) went to FAU and lost 33-27. AF is off a 49-45 loss to Utah St, but are at home for the 3rd time in 4 wks while FAU travels out west after facing FCS Fordham last wk. FAU has exp vs the option & just faced GSthrn 2 wks ago and won, but this AF team is better than GSthrn in our eyes. The AF D had all'd just 178 ypg & 9 ppg but they gave up 628 yds & 49 pts to USU last wk. The AF D does have 10 sks in 3 gms & are all'g 86 rush ypg (2.7). FAU's OL has paved the way for 182 (4.2) but have all'd 11 sks in 3 gms. FAU is throwing for 298 ypg & the AF secondary all'd 448 pass yds to Utah St last wk. AF

is 16-6 ATS s/15 against non-conf foes & while FAU is 6-2 ATS the L3Y as a dog we think they get worn down in the 2H by the altitude (6,778 ft) & AF takes this game by a TD.

UTAH by 21 over Washington St - After a rough home outing LW against USC where they blew an early 14-0 lead in an eventual 45-14 defeat (4★ LP Winner on USC!), the Cougars head to SLC to take on a Utes squad that fell in 3OT LW at SDSt (Utah 21-12 FD & 327-248 yd edges) with bkp QB Rising (153 yds & 3 TD's) taking over for the ineffective Brewer (104 yds & 1 int). LY the Utes (-10') trailed 28-7 at HT before scoring 38 unanswered pts in a 45-28 victory (all-time series is tied 9-9, WSU has won 4 of the L/6). With the Utes having covered 11 of their L/14 P12 matchups coming in and WSU just 4-11 ATS in their meetings with conf foes, the home team gets the edge in this one.

Hawaii by 16 over NEW MEXICO ST - First of 2 regular ssn meetings. All-time UH is 8-0 SU against NMSt with all 8 wins coming by DD's. Their last mtg came as WAC foes back in '11 when UH (-21') won 45-34 at home. After a slow start vs UCLA, UH's offense is avg'g 465 ypg the L/3 gms led by QB Corderio and for the ssn they are avg'g 289 pass ypg & face a NMSt pass D that has all'd over 350 pass yds the L/2 gms. The NMSt run D has also all'd 210 ypg (4.8) this ssn vs FBS foes. UH's weak point this ssn had been their D as they were all'g 476 ypg/41 ppg their F/3 gms but held SJSt to 291 yds/17 pts. NMSt is avg'g just 334 ypg/20 ppg, but are avg'g 294 pass ypg the L/3 gms. UH is just 6-18-1 ATS the L6Y as chalk and NMSt have covered their L/2 gms as a DD dog. While we seé UH winning, NMSt is showing fight & hanging around, which we see happening again here. BYU by 28 over Usf - 2nd ever meeting, with the Bulls having pulled the outright upset at home in (19 27-23 (+4'), despite BYU leading at HT 16-7 and holding a distinct yd and FD edge for the gm (+124 and 26-17). USF is 0-2 SU and ATS vs. FBS opponents this ssn, while BYU is coming off BZB outright upsets of top-25 tms including arch rival Utah 26-17 (+7) and Arizona St 27-17 (+3'). The Bulls have endured abysmal QB play, W/ their two main options completing a combined 49% of their passes with 0 TDs and 4 INTs vs FBS tms. USF was rolled 45-0 (+19) by NC St in their only road , gm so far. We expect the Cougers to cruise at home by 4 scores

ARIZONA ST by 16 over Colorado - Following a 10 pt loss LW in Provo against BYU where they turned the ball over 4 times and had 16 penalties for 121 yards (ASU 426-361 yd edge), the Sun Devils return to the desert to take on a Buffs squad that was held to just 63 yds in a 30-0 defeat in Boulder. While Colorado had actually dropped the first 7 in the series with ASU, they have actually picked up victories in 3 of the past 4 since including 2019 where they came away with a 34-31 win as a 7' pt dog (CU's 1st road win over a ranked team in 17 years!). However, the Buffs have failed to cover 5 of the L/7 as an AD which has us leaning with a Sun Devils squad who covered 3 of their 4 P12 contests a year ago.

USC by 6 over Oregon St - The Trojans got off to a nice start LW under interim HC Donte Williams as they overcame an early 14-0 deficit in the eventual 45-14 victory (4★ LP Winner!) with bkp QB Dart throwing for 391 yds & 4 TD's for Kedon Slovis who left early with injury. The Beavers meanwhile moved to 2-1 for the year after easily dispatching FCS Idaho 42-0 with 23-14 FD & 438-192 yd edges. USC has won the L/4 in the series (3-1 ATS) including a 38-21 (-15) victory in Corvallis back in '18. With OSU still in search of their first win vs USC in the Coliseum S/60 (lost 23 straight!), we're not counting on that streak to end anytime soon. Covering this meeting is another question however as the Beavers are an outstanding 9-1 ATS when listed as an AD.

Louisville by 6 over FLORIDA ST - UL is 7-3 ATS in this series but the home team is 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS. UL has extra rest after their upset win over UCF where the Cardinals were tied and got a pick 6 with just :13 left. UL has lost 3 straight road openers (0-2-1 ATS) including LTH when FSU got 2 td's in the last 7:25 and won 35-24 (-6'). FSU is 0-3 for the first time since 1976, ironically that was legendary HC Bobby Bowden's first year. Last week FSU was off their FCS loss and fell behind WF 14-0 1Q. The 'Noles finished -167 yds, -11 FD's and -4 TO's. Jordan Travis was more effective at QB, throwing for 107 and 2 td's while Milton threw for 119 and 2 int's on 10 more attempts. The 'Noles are allowing 289 pass ypg and UL QB Cunningham has his best performance of the year, throwing for 265. At this point we can't back FSU and UL is confident with extra rest and Satterfield is 14-7 as an AF going back to App St so the Cardinals get a 10 point edge here.

OKLAHOMA ST by 3 over Kansas St - 68th meeting & OSU holds a 41-26 lead. More recently OSU is 9-5 SU against KSt since '03 but KSt is on a 13-4 ATS run dating back to '98. LY KSt jumped out to a 12-0 HT lead but OSU would score 20 straight & KSt missed the tying 2-pt conv late 4Q in a 20-18 loss. In LY's mtg KSt started frosh QB Howard & he will start here after Skylar Thompson got hurt 2 wks ago, but KSt is having success running (226, 5.3) so there won't be a ton of pressure on Howard. OSŬ is putting up just 337 ypg & 20 ppg as they have had several offensive players banged up, meanwhile KSt's D is holding foes to 280 ypg & 16 ppg and have collected 13 sks in 3 gms. With both teams having a pretty solid D (OSU holding foes to 329 ypg/20 ppg) and neither offense is lighting it up we see & this gm being decided by a FG. KSt is also 11-5 ATS under Klieman as a dog. ALABAMA by 41 over Southern Miss- Last met in 19 when Bama was -38 and won 49-7. SMiss did cover the 2 previous mtgs as 45' & 12' pt dogs. Bama led FL 21-3 1Q but needed a stop on a 2 pt conv to hold on and only won 31-29 (-14'). The Tide were outg'd 440-331 and out FD'd 26-19. SMiss put up just 156 yds last week in their 21-9 (+11) loss to Troy. The Golden Eagles had -1 rush yd. They nearly had a backdoor push after a fumble ret td but the PAT was blocked. Nick Saban is just 6-13 ATS as favorites of 40 pts or more. This is also a home game for the Tide, and while they surely will get a big first half lead, they will have plenty of walk-ons to fill the 4Q and we with a showdown against Ole Miss on deck, the starters will get pulled early so our lean is with the dog. Georgia by 41 over VANDERBILT - UGA has won L/3 mtgs by 28 ppg (3-0 ATS). Vandy did cover 4 straight from '13-'16. The Dawgs have allowed just 20 pts in 3 games this season and the only 2 td's they've given up have come in garbage time of blowouts. Last week UGA beat SCar 40-13 (-31'). They led 26-6 at half and had a 17-4 FD edge. QB Daniels ret'd from injury and threw for 303 and 3 td's. We won our 4★ on these pages (and a 3★ LPS) going against Vandy last week in their 41-23 loss to Stanford. The 'Dores last td came on the very final play of the game. The Dawgs do have a ranked Arkansas squad on deck but Vandy had 4 losses of 30+ pts last year and we don't mind go-ing against the 'Dores again. This game has gone under in 4 of the last 5 mtgs and we will certainly consider the 'Under' as our Totals GOM considering UGA might have the best D in the country.

STANFORD by 1 over Ucla - The Cardinal picked up a 2nd consecutive win LW in Nashville against Vandy (4★ Newsletter & 3★ LP Winner!) with QB McKee combining for 3 TD's in 41-23 victory. They now FINALLY return home to "The Farm" after 7 straight games being played away from Palo Alto (L/4 in '20 due to Covid, F/3 this ssn). The Bruins meanwhile suffered their 1st loss of the year LW in the Rose Bowl to Fresno St who connected on a GW 13 yd TD pass with :14 left (FSU 32-17 & 569-395 yd edges). UCLA has actually lost 12 of the L/13 meetings against the Cardinal (2-11 ATS) including LY in 2OT, a game in which they actually came back from an early 20-3 deficit to force the extra time. With the Cardinal being an impressive 11-2 ATS as a HD dating back to 2010 and the Bruins failing to cover 6 straight as an AF since 2016, the home team gets the upset here!

HOUSTON by 27 over Navy - Navy has experienced an uncharacteristically tumultuous start to their ssn, having by blown out in both their gms as single-digit dogs by 20 or more pts, including a laughable performance vs Air Force at home (+6') in which they managed only 68 yds of total offense and lost 23-3. Ivin Jasper had been the OC since '08 but was let go following the gm, only to be brought back 2 days later as the QB coach. Houston has recovered after their opening collapse against Texas Tech (PK) after leading 14-0 before the Red Raiders offense even saw the field, having gone 2-0 SU and ATS since. We think the Cougs start AAC play with a 4-score route.

OKLAHOMA by 20 over West Virginia - OU holds a 10-2 series lead and have won all 8 mtgs as

B12 foes SU. Last mtg was in '19 and OU (-32') thrashed WVU 52-14 at home (560-242). OU is off a 27-13 win Neb at home while WVU is off a 27-21 win vs VTech (3★ LP winner on Under 50). The OU offense has put up 487 ypg and 46 ppg led by QB Rattler & the WU pass D struggled earlier this ssn against Maryland (332 yds, 72% all'd). Against 2 FBS foes WVU's offense has looked just okay (347 ypg/26 ppg) and here they face an OU D that has held foes to 89 ypg under their ssn avg. OU is also all g just 83 ypg rush (2.5) and have 8 sks in 3 gms. WVU's D is all g 307 ypg & collected 6 sks last wk. WVU is also 5 TO's on the year while OU is +5 TO's. OU is on a 5-0-1 ATS run against WVU and we think the Sooners & their high-powered offense take this gm by nearly 3 td's. Also the 'OVER' has also hit in 6 straight gms between these B12 foes.

Lsu by 6 over MISSISSIPPI ST - LSU is out for revenge after being upset in the opener 44-34 (-16') last year. LSU was w/o CB Stingley in that game and was breaking in 17 new starters following their Nat'l Title ssn and facing Mike Leach's offense for the first time. LSU was w/o several players last week but still beat CMich 49-21. The Tigers had a 42-7 lead and Max Johnson threw for 372 and 5 td's. Miss St finished with +222 yd & +14 FD edges last week but allowed a fumble ret td, a 94 yd PR td when they thought they downed the ball and stopped, and a 36 yd td drive in their 31-29 (-3'). QB Rogers threw for 419 and 3 td's and now has an 8-1 ratio but he faces an LSU D that is all'g 58% (193 pass ypg) and has 17 sks (23%)! The Tigers are 25-4 SU vs Miss St s/1992 and they haven't ost B2B since '91 so we'll call for the Tigers to get revenge by almost a td.

Wyoming by 38 over CONNECTICUT - First meeting. WY makes their 1st trip to the Eastern Time Zone since '16. WY is off a dominant 45-12 win at home vs BSU where they scored 21 pts off TO's incl 2 pick-6's. It took UConn 34 poss but they finally scored a TD vs an FBS foe, but still lost to Army 52-21 (225-504). UConn's offense (204 ypg/12 ppg) may struggle vs a WY defense that is all'g 353 ypg. WY is also +5 in TO's this ssn and have 10 sks in 3 gms incl 6 sks a week ago! UConn's D has all'd 535 ypg/49 ppg against FBS foes & overall this ssn have all'd 242 rush ypg (4.9) and are all'g 72% completions. WY wanted a more balanced OFF attack & they are getting that this ssn (173 rush ypg, 200 pass ypg). WY did go just 1-3 ATS LY as an AF but have a bye on deck and even with their backdoor cover LW we cannot lean with UConn.

TULANE by 4 over Uab - With these two tms having first met in '99, this modern mathcup has been extremely competitive, w/ the series tied at 5 wins apiece. The underdog has actually pulled an outright upset in 6 of the previous 7 meetings, including in their last encounter in 18. the Green Wave crashed into Birmingham as slight favorites (-3') but trailed wire-to-wire before falling to the Blazers 31-24. In their two gms against FCS opponents, downtrodden Morgan St hasn't combined to put up as many pts as the 20 they hung on Tulane before the Green Wave were trounced LW by Ole Miss in Oxford (+14') 61-21. We think Tulane pulls it out at home by just over a FG.

TEXAS by 7 over Texas Tech - These B12 rivals have met 70 times with UT holding a 53-17 series lead. Moré recently UT is 9-2 SU/8-3 ATS against TTU since 2010. LY TTU (+17') led Texas 56-41 with under 4 min left 4Q but UT scored twice & then won the gm 63-56 OT. UT bounced back with a 58-0 win over Rice last wk while TTU is off to a 3-0 start after a 54-21 win vs FIU. Texas is trying to find a new QB & both Card/Thompson have shown flashes but have been inconsistent and face a TTU D that is all'g 291 ypg/21 ppg and are holding foes to 55 rush ypg (1.8). The TTU offense (441 ypg/40 ppg) faces a UT D that held Rice to 284 yds but 2 wks ago all'd 333 rush yds to Ark & TTU is ávg'g 174 rush ypg (5.7). TTU has dropped their L/2 B12 road openers ATS under HC Wells but UT is on a 2-4-1 ATS slide in B12 home openers & we think TTU keep this one close.

MEMPHIS by 1 over Utsa- First mtg. Memphis enters off a home upset over SEC foe Miss St despite getting outgained by 222 yds. The Tigers got a fumble recovery td, a PR when Miss St tried to down the punt but the play wasn't blown dead and the Tigers PR Austin picked it up and ran 94 yds for a td, as well as a 36 yd td drive. After putting up 634 ypg in their F/2, Memphis only had 246 vs Miss St. UTSA is 3-0 for the first time in '17. The Roadrunners only led 10-0 at half LW vs Middle Tenn but they did have a 257-56 yd edge and MT's 2 td's came in garbage time of UTSA's 27-13 (-12') win. Memphis has allowed just 82 rush ypg (3.3) but get their toughest test, facing UTSA's McCormick who has 268 (4.5). UTSA avg 459 ypg and is +214 ypg, are on an 8-3 run as an AD with a Power 5 road upset of their own so we think the Roadrunners keep it close.

TCU by 6 over Smu - 100th mtg in the "Battle of the Iron Skillet" and TCU holds a 51-41-7 lead. TCU has won 7 of the L/8 mtgs but in the most recrent game in '19 SMU (+8) never trailed in a 41-38 road upset. TCU is off a bye while SMU is 3-0 & are off a dramatic 39-37 win vs LA Tech where they completed a hail mary on the final play. SMU's offense is avg'g 535 ypg/43 ppg & TCU's D did allow 442 yds/32 pts to Cal 2 wks ago. Impressively SMU has not all'd a sack this ssn on 118 pass att!

SMU's D has struggled this ssn (495 total ypg & 368 pass ypg all'd vs FBS foes) and TCU's offense put up 498 yds vs Cal. S' 16 TCU is just 6-17-2 ATS as a HF while SMU is 8-2 ATS the L3Y vs nonconf foes. We think SMU has the offensive firepower to hang with TCU.

Iowa St by 6 over BAYLOR - ISU has won 3 of the L/4 gms SU but have failed to cover 3 straight vs BU. LY BU jumped out to a 21-7 lead 2Q and led 24-10 3Q before ISU scored 28 straight pts & won 38-31. Both tms enter off easy wins as ISU beat UNLV 48-3 (493-130) while BU won 45-7 at Kansas (576-166). BU avg 559 ypg/47 ppg and are led by new QB Bohannon but face a stingy ISU D that has all'fd just 193 ypg/13 ppg this ssn and have collected 9 sks in 3 mms while RI has just 3 sks in 3 has all'd just 193 ypg/13 ppg this ssn and have collected 9 sks in 3 gms while BU has just 3 sks in 3 gms. ISU's offense got on track last wk but now face a tough BU D that is all'g just 227 ypg/11 ppg! Both tms also posses strong OL's as ISU has all'd just 3 sks while BU has all'd just 1 sk this ssn. With both teams bringing strong D's into this matchup we see this gm being decided by less than a TD.

FLORIDA by 23 over Tennessee- Florida is 15-1 SU/11-5 ATS in this series. Last year UF led 31-7 (-17') and UT added 2 td's in garbage time. After falling behind Bama 21-3 1Q last week, the Gatos controlled the LOS and nearly tied the game late but missed a 2 pt conv. UF ran for 245 (5.7) despite not having their leading rusher, bkp QB Anthony Richardson. The Gators avg 340 rush ypg (7.7), and have allowed just 2 sks. The Vols bounced back off their loss to Pitt and beat Tenn Tech 56-0 (-40'). Hendon Hooker got the start at QB with Joe Milton still hurt. The Vols have allowed just 54 rush ypg (1.7) but have yet to face a potent rush offense. The Gators did lose LY's leading tkl'r, LB Miller, for the ssn but they still held Bama to 91 rush (3.4) and we see UF rolling here by more than 3 td's.

Clemson by 15 over NC STATE - Clemson is 15-1 SU over NCSt and is 4-2 ATS. The home team

is just 7-16 ATS. Clem needed a late SOD to hold on against GTech LW, winning 14-8 (-27'). NCSt enters fresh off an easy win over FCS Furman 45-7 (-27). The 'Pack were ply'g their first game wo their leader on D, LB Wilson who is OFY. The 'Pack have rushed for 181 (5.7) but 2 wks ago were held to just 32 rush yds (1.3) at Miss St in a 14 pt loss and the Tigers are only allowing 110 ypg (3.2) against a tougher sked and have yet to allow an off td. The public is off Clemson but they still have one of the best cch's in the country and while QB Uiagalelei only has 474 pass, he did throw for 781 comb'd against BC & ND last year. The Tigers have a huge Def edge and given up 0 in the last 2.

Clem is 12-6-1 as an AF and we think they take this game by just over 2 td's.

MICHIGAN ST by 8 over Nebraska - The Cornhuskers lead the series 9-2, and have won 2 straight dating back to '15. Following their dominant showing against NW on the road in the opener 38-21 (+3), and RB Walker's dazzling performance, MSU beat up on Youngstown St before pulling an (+3), afful NB Walker's dazzining perioritiative, initiative, initiative and the perioritiative outright upset on the rd LW vs #24 Miami (+6') 38-17, w/ another great day for Walker (493, 8.6, 5 TDs in 3 gms). After their wk 1A upset loss at Illinois (-7), 30-22, Nebraska has gone 3-0 ATS and played #3 Oklahoma tough on the road (-24 yds, 18-21 FDs) as massive dogs (+22'), losing 23-16. OB Martinez has played well (1,017, 66%, 5/1 in 4 gms), but we think MSU wins by over a TD.

MICHIGAN by 10 over Rutgers - Michigan has dominated the series 6-1 by winning 6 straight, w/ Rutgers having not won since their innaugeral ssn in the B10 in '14, 26-24 (-1'). The Scarlet Knights have shown rapid improvement since rejoining forces w/ HC Greg Schiano, having started this ssn 3-0 both SU and ATS, and are 8-4 ATS since his rearrival in NJ LY. This will be Rutgers' first gm as an underdog TY, but they went 4-0 ATS as AD LY, including 3 outright upsets. The Wolverines are also

3-0 SU and ATS TY and have mauled opponents on the ground, averaging 350 ypg (7.1). Both these defenses are allowing just 11 ppg though and we think Rutgers keeps it just over a TD.

Troy by 27 over ULM - Troy has won the L/2 gms SU & have also covered the L/3 meetings. Despite being SBC foes the last time they met was in 18 where Troy jumped out to a 35-7 lead but held on at the end for a 35-27 win. Troy is holding foes to 228 ypg/11 ppg and LW vs SMiss they all'd just 156 yds (-1 rush yd!) and collected 9 sks! For the ssn Troy's D has 16 sks on 66 pass att (24.2%!) and face a ULM OL that has all'd 9 sks in 2 gms. ULM avg just 169 ypg/11 ppg but Troy's offense hasn't had a hot start either (333 ypg) but face a ULM D that all'd 554 yds in the opener. ULM is just 5-11 ATS the L/3 as a DD dog while Troy is 5-2 ATS under HC Lindsey as an AF. Under Lindsey 8 of Troy's PERS wins are by 20L pte and we think they call II M have be people 4 to 15.

9 FBS wins are by 20+ pts and we think they roll ULM here by nearly 4 td's. **AUBURN by 28 over Georgia St** - First meeting. Auburn is 22-0 SU all-time vs current SBC foes. GSt picked up their first win of the ssn last wk against Charlotte 20-9 (3★ LP winner on GSt) as they held the 49ers to just 276 yds, but GSt QB Brown was benched & the bkp Grainger had 203 ttl yds. Auburn is off a 28-20 loss in white out conditions at Penn St (3★ LP winner on PSU). GSt's run game showed up last week (298, 6.1) but face a stingy Auburn rush D that is allowing just 46 ypg (1.4). Though it is early Auburn's pass D is all'g 79% completions & gave up 29-33 for 302 last wk vs PSU. While Auburn does have their SEC opener at LSU on deck the Tigers are 8-2 ATS the L3Y as a HF while GSt is just 3-8-2 ATS under Elliott as a DD dog.

TULSA over Arkansas St by 16 - The Red Wolves lead this series 3-2, having won the last meeting

in '18. Tulsa is just 4-13 in non-conf play L5Y and are winless to begin this ssn, but after a troubling opening loss to FCS UC Davis 19-17 (-23') where 9 players were suspended, Tulsa has gone 2-0 ATS in road gms vs. Oklahoma St and Ohio St. LW the Golden Hurricane put up 501 yds of total offense w/ a 25-24 FD edge vs OSU (+24') in a gm they trailed 27-20 w/ just over 3:00 to play. Arkansas St were manhandled on the road by Washington LW (+17) 52-3. The Wolves allowed 1,278 total yds their last 2 gms and we think Tulsa gets off the schneid at home by more than 2 TDs. Buffalo by 11 over OLD DOMINION - First mtg. UB kept it close last week with Coastal Car, only losing 28-25 (+14). The Bulls led 14-7 2Q and was only outgained 460-408. ODU trailed Liberty on the road 28-17 at half, but was held to just 47 yds and shutout in the 2H of their 45-17 (+27) loss. The Monarchs have lost 14 straight vs FBS foes (4-10 ATS). UB has also allowed 0 sks in 3 games. The Bulls have solid edges on OFF & D and despite the late arrival, new HC Linguist has them competitive so we like the Bulls to win by DD's.

LOUISIANA TECH by 6 over North Texas- LT is 8-2 SU/ATS in this series and the Bulldogs are on a 3 game series streak after LY's 42-31 (pk) road win, though the Bulldogs. LT easily covered last week as 13' pt dogs vs SMU but would have given us our 2nd outright Underdog POW on these pages had they not allowed a hailmary td. QB Kendall threw for 351 and 4 td's. NT took on aUAB team off an embarassing loss to UGA and lost 40-6 (+12'). NT did play SMU 2 wks ago and were only -31 yds but lost 35-12 after settling for 2 short fg's, 2 int's and were SOD in SMU territory 4x. NT is -109 ypg but LT is only -102 ypg and the yardage difference vs SMU was actually closer for NT. We won't call for the upset but NT can keep this closer than expected if they avoid costly TO's. New Mexico by 3 over UTEP - Last mtg came back in '14 when UTEP (+7.5) pulled the road upset, winning 31-24. Both teams started their ssn 2-0 with each team getting a win over NMexSt and an

FCS team. Last week NM was held to 122 yds in a 34-0 loss vs A&M while UTEP is off a bye, but 2 wks ago lost 54-13 at Boise (-5 TO's). NM is led by UK transfer QB Wilson (593, 66%, 6-1) who threw for 381 vs NMexSt but here faces a UTEP pass D that is all'g just 51% completions. UTEP's offense did throw for 340 vs Boise & are led by WR Cowing (293, 22.5, 3 td). NMex is all'g just 85 rush ypg (3.2) and have 8 sks incl 3 LW. We see NMex pulling the slim road upset here by a FG.

4★ PITTSBURGH over Cincinnati - Following a surprising 26-17 defeat LW at home against the Raiders where they had 22-17 FD & 425-331 yd deficits, the Steelers are back inside of Heinz Field for a 2nd straight week to take on a Bengals squad that fell just short of getting to 2-0 LW in Soldier Field (CIN 248-206 yd edge, -3 TO's). After picking up wins in 11 straight against the Bengals (14 pt avg MOV) dating back to 15, the Steelers (-13) suffered a shocking upset on MNF last December (CIN led 17-0 at HT). With revenge on their mind from that matchup along with a 5-1 ATS mark in DIV HG's, we'll call for PIT to get the job done here as CIN has failed to cover 7 of their L/10 dating FORECAST: PITTSBURGH by 13

3★ NEW ENGLAND over New Orleans - Following an outstanding performance in Wk 1 where they blew out the Packers, the Saints came back to reality LW on the road against the Panthers who finished with 28-6 FD & 383-128 yd edges in a 26-7 victory (NO's fewest yds since 2001). The Patriots return to Foxboro after their 1st win of the year LW at the Jets where they forced 4 int's by rookie QB Zach Wilson (3★ LP Winner on NE!). While the Saints are 15-5 ATS as an AD coming in, they have dropped 5 of their L/6 meetings against the Patriots including a 16 pt loss inside of the Superdome in '17 where NE had 29-20 FD and 555-429 yard edges. FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 10 in '17 where NE had 29-20 FD and 555-429 yard edges.

2★ La Chargers (+) over KANSAS CITY - The Chargers fell just short of moving to 2-0 on the year with the Cowboys getting a GW 56 yd FG as time expired LW. The Chiefs meanwhile blew an 11 pt lead in the 4Q at BAL in a 36-35 defeat. Prior to LY's Wk 17 win over the Chiefs (KC resting starters), LAC has dropped 12 of 13 in the series. Dating back to LY, the Chargers are now on a 4-1-1 ATS run while the Chiefs have failed to cover 10 regular ssn contests. With KC also going just 1-5 ATS inside FORECAST: KANSAS CITY by 1 of the AFC West a year ago, we'll lean with the visitor here. OTHER PLAYS

Carolina at HOUSTON - Thursday - The Panthers head to Houston for their 1st road game of the season after posting victories in each of their first 2 matchups against the Jets (5 pt win) and Saints (allowed just 6 FD's & 128 yds in a 26-7 win). The Texans meanwhile are back at home following a road loss in CLE where QB Tyrod Taylor was lost to injury (CS here, rookie QB Davis Mills 8-18-102-1-1 in relief). The Panthers have won 3 consecutive matchups against the Texans including a 16-10 victory back in '19 where RB Christian McCaffrey had 179 total yards. While the Texans are just 4-8-1 ATS in recent meetings with the NFC, their first home game of the year was impressive as they picked up a 37-21 win over JAX as a 3 pt dog. We'll have one of our Marquee selections

available after Noon EST on gameday.

Arizona by 10 over JACKSONVILLE - The Cardinals are back on the road for a 2nd time in 3 wks after hanging on to a 34-33 win over the Vikings (3.5★ LP Winner on Over 50.5!). Their season opening win on the road against the Titans was arguably the most impressive performance of the season as they recorded a 38-13 victory as a 3 pt dog. The Jags are now sitting at 0-2 this year as the Broncos held them to just 12 FD's & 189 yds in a 23-13 victory. Following a pair of defeats in their first 2 matchups in this series, the Cardinals have since rattled off 3 consecutive victories including a 27-24 win in the desert back in '17 (344-219 yd edge, GW 57-yd FG w/:01 left!). With ARZ posting a 7-3 ATS mark in NDIV AG's and JAX failing to cover 29 of their L/37 against the NFC, the road team gets a solid lean in this one.

TENNESSEE by 10 over Indianapolis - Huge early season matchup against the Colts and Titans who finished tied atop the AFC South LY at 11-5. After dropping 16 of their 17 meetings from '08-'16, the Titans have split the last 8 against IND (road team has won and covered 5 straight!). The Colts head to Nashville following a 2nd straight home loss against the NFC West as the Rams got the GW 38-yd FG w/2:23 left in the 27-24 victory. The Titans meanwhile rebounded from an ugly Wk 1 matchup at home against the Cardinals with a 3 pt road upset (+6') of the Seahawks in the Pacific NW (3★ LP & 2★ Newsletter Winner, TEN 33-17 FD & 532-397 yd edges). With the Colts in the midst of a 3-game road stretch (at MIA & BAL the next 2 wks) and the Titans having a solid 9-4 ATS mark as a DIV HF, the home squad gets the DD edge here as IND could be without QB Carson Wentz in this one after leaving LW's game with injury.

Baltimore by 12 over DETROIT - The Ravens head back on the road following a 36-35 comeback victory at home against the Chiefs where Lamar Jackson had 239 yds passing, 107 yds rushing and 3 combined TD's. The Lions meanwhile return home on short rest after a MNF tilt against the Packers in Lambeau. The Ravens have won 4 of their 5 all-time meetings against the Lions with a 44-20 win in '17 being the last time they faced off (DET 372-370 yd edge, -3 TO's). With DET just 7-13-1 ATS as a NDIV HD and the Ravens (7-1 ATS run) looking to continue their momentum, we have no issue backing the visitor.

BUFFALO by 13 over Washington - Rematch of SB XXVI where Washington picked up a 37-24 victory (BUF trailed 17-0 at HT). Since that defeat, the Bills have rattled off victories in 7 of the L/8 including a 24-9 home victory in '19. BUF got back on track LW on the road against the Dolphins (4\* Newsletter Winner) as their defense allowed just 13 FD's & 216 yds in the 35-0 win. WAS is also sitting at 1-1 on the year after picking up 1 pt win last Thur against the Giants with a GW 43-yd FG as time expired. While WAS is an impressive 10-5-1 ATS as an AD and has cashed in 4 of their L/5 road openers, we're backing the home squad here as BUF is 7-1 ATS against NFC foes and has

covered 9 of their L/10 regular season games overall.

NY GIANTS by 3 over Atlanta - Battle of a pair of 0-2 squads as the Falcons head to MetLife following a 23 pt loss against the Bucs where QB Matt Ryan tossed 3 int's including 2 that were returned for TD's. The Giants do return home with extra rest after a Thur night meeting with WAS where they fell just short of a mild upset (WAS GW 43-yd FG as time expired). The Falcons have picked up victories in 3 of their L/4 meetings against the Giants including a 3 pt home win in '18 (NYG backdoor cover TD w/:05 left). Despite that recent success, the Falcons appear to be headed for an 0-3 start as we'll

give the home team a FG edge in this one.

CLEVELAND by 3 over Chicago - The Bears and Browns head into this matchup following Wk 2 victories as CHI picked up a 3 pt home win against the Bengals with rookie QB Justin Fields seeing action in the 2H for an injured Andy Dalton (6-13-60-0-1, 31 rush) while CLE knocked off the Texans by a 31-21 score with 22-16 FD & 355-302 yd edges. The Browns have dropped 3 straight against the Bears including a 20-3 defeat in '17 where they were held to just 12 FD's and 253 yards. While they also went a perfect 4-0 ATS against the NFC a year ago, we're cutting off our lean at a FG as CHI has enough defensive talent to keep this one tight.

Miami by 1 over LAS VEGAS - The Raiders are back at home following a 2-0 start to the season which includes a 9 pt upset win over the Steelers LW (425-331 yd edge). The Dolphins meanwhile suffered an embarrassing home loss to the Bills in a game that QB Tua Tagovailoa was lost early with injury (4★ Newsletter Winner on BUF, MIA outgained 314-216). The Dolphins have won 10 of the past 12 in this series including a miracle comeback win LY in "Sin City" where they got the GW 44-yd FG w/:01 left (MIA 5-1-1 ATS run). While they continue to be outgained at an alarming rate, MIA somehow puts together victories including Wk 1 in Foxboro where they picked up a 1 pt win despite a 393-259 yd disadvantage. With the Dolphins also 9-4 ATS as an AD and covering 12 of their L/17 dating back to LY, we expect them to get the outright win here no matter who lines up at QB (Jacoby Brissett 24-40-169-0-1 LW vs BUF).

DENVER by 14 over Ny Jets - After spending their first 2 games of the season out East against the Giants (24-19 FD & 420-314 yd edges in a 14 pt win) and Jaguars (22-12 FD & 398-189 yd edges in a 10 pt win), the Broncos return home to take on a Jets squad that they've knocked off in 4 of the past 5 matchups including a 37-28 road victory a year ago. The Jets are sitting at 0-2 following a 19 pt home loss to the Patriots where we picked up a 3★ LP Winner! Tampa Bay by 3 over LA RAMS - Big early season matchup in the NFC as the defending champs head on the road for the first time TY (2-0 with wins over DAL & ATL) to take on a Rams squad that's also sitting at 2-0 following a 3 pt win LW in IND where WR Cooper Kupp had 163 yds & 2 TD's. The Rams have collected wins in 6 of their L/7 against the Bucs including a 27-24 road win a year ago (413-251 yd edge).
