Ohio State by 13 over RUTGERS - The Buckeyes are 7-0 all-time vs. Rutgers but the Scarlet Knights have covered in B2B meetings, closing the scoring gap by DD yr over yr. Rutgers is now 9-4 ATS since Schiano's return in '20 and are 4-0 ATS to start this ssn after winning both the yd and FD edge at Michigan LW (+77, 21-15) as huge dogs (+20\*), but their comeback attempt fell short, 20-13. The Scarlet Knights held the nation's #1 rushing attack to 112 yds (2.9) and overall RU's D is all'g just 264 ypg/14 ppg & are holding foes to 171 ypg under their ssn avg (#5 FBS!). W/ starting QB CJ Stroud out, the Bucks handled woeful Akron (-48\*), 59-7, piling up +393 yds and a FD edge of 26-17. We have not been impressed with OSU this ssn & think RU can hang around in this game.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 35 over ULM - As SBC foes ULM is 3-0 against CCU. Last mtg was in 2019 when the lead changed 7 times and ULM (-6) prevailed in a 45-42 offensive shootout. CCU is off to a 4-0 start and this is their 4th home game in 5 wks. ULM had their SBC opener last wk vs Troy & picked up a surprising 29-16 win (3★ LP winner on Under 50!). ULM's offense is gaining just 209 ypg and scoring just 17 ppg and have all'd 11 sks in 3 gms. Meanwhile ULM's D is all'g 406 ypg and are giving up 330 pass ypg (69%) and CCU QB McCall (901, 8-1) is hitting 77%. ULM's rush D has all'd just 76 (3.1) but faces a strong CCU run gm avg of 250 rush ypg (6.3). ULM is 4-6 ATS the L2Y as a DD dog, but CCU has a SBC road gm in 5 days and could rest key starters up big in the 2H.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 1 over Eastern Michigan - NIU is 17-3 SU (10-10 ATS) in series but Visitor is 14-6 ATS. EM has won & covered L/2 (last won 3 str '56-'58). EM is 3-1 SU TY but 1-3 ATS. EM covered LW vs a Texas St tm off a SU loss to an FCS team, hanging an EM non-conc record 59 pts (21 in 4Q) to win by 38 as a 7 pt HF. LW NIU scored the final 27 vs Maine pitching a 2H shutout & covering as a 21 pt HF. Huskies have played a much tougher schedule (#64-#124) & beat a Georgia Tech team 22-21 as a 19 pt AD, that covered their other 3 games incl a 23 pt upset win LW over #21 NC. EM is great as a dog but are just 3-5 ATS incl 3 outright losses thru L/8 as a favorite, so we will take the "dog" Huskies here and will call for the outright upset.

BOISE ST by 2 over Nevada - Boise has won 16 of the L/17 mtgs SU but since 2009 Nev has covered 6 of the 8 gms. Nev is off a bye & 2 wks ago lost at KSt 38-17 (gm tied 17-17 after 3Q. Nev all'd 21 straight pts) while Boise is off their MW opener at UTSt where all'd 443 yds but gave up just 3 pts (+2 TO's). This ssn Nev is avg'g 353 pass ypg (QB Strong 955, 68%, 7-2) and Boise all'd 318 pass yds to UCF earlier this ssn. Nev has only rushed for 77 ypg (3.4) but face a Boise run D that is giving up 210 ypg (4.5). Boise avg 283 ypg (62%) but face a Nev pass D that is all'g just 149 ypg (64%). Nev is 6-2 ATS as a single-digit MW underdog under HC Norvell & we think they hang with Boise and it wouldn't shock us if the 'Pack pull off the outright road upset.

Air Force by 7 over NEW MEXICO - AF holds a 24-14 edge in the series and they have won the L/3 mtgs overall SU and have outscored NMex 114-46 in those gms. However NMex has covered 8 of the L/11 mtgs. AF got back on track last wk with a 31-7 win vs FAU where they ran for 446 yds (6.1) and held FAU to 261 ypg under their ssn avg. NMex has lost their L/2 gms & have just 410 total yds & 13 total pts in those gms. AF's D all'd 628 yds to USU 2 wks ago but in the other 3 gms have all'd 574 total yds & 24 total pts. NMex's D (led by great DC Rocky Long) is all'g just 326 ypg/24 ypg and Long is used to seeing the option. NMex was 3-0 ATS LY as a home dog vs MW foes including 2 outright upsets & we think the Lobos can hang tough with AF.

usc by 15 over COLORADO - Following a rough 18 pt home loss against the Beavers where QB Kedon Slovis was forced into 3 int's in his return from injury, the Trojans head back on the road to take on a Buffs squad that was held to just 13 points and 250 yards in a 22 point defeat. USC has come out on top in all 14 meetings against the Buffs (2-3 ATS in Boulder since CU joined the P12 in '11) including LTH when QB Slovis threw for 406 yds & 4 TD's in a 35-31 comeback win. With the Trojans cover 5 of their L/6 as an AF coming in (45-14 win 2 wks ago at WSU) and CU being held to just 10 ppg and 191 ypg the L/3 weeks, the visitor gets the edge in this one.

Cincinnati by 2 over NOTRE DAME - The Bearcats had an extra wk to prepare for the most important gm to their playoff resume, and looked impressive down the stretch at Indiana (-3'), outscoring the Hoosiers 38-10 in the final 32.5 minutes to win 38-24. ND looked vulnerable the first 2 wks, needing OT to beat winless FSU on the road (-7) by a FG and a TD heave w/ just over a min left to beat Toledo at home (-17) 32-29. LW the Irish lost QB Coan to inj and trailed 13-10 4Q vs Wisconsin (+6), but used 2 pick-6's in the last 2:30 for a deceiving 41-13 win (3★ LP winner on the Irish!). While Cincy's pass rush only has 4 sks this ssn they face a ND OL that has all'd 20 sks in 4 gms (14.3%). We like Cincy to go into ND and come away with the win.

SAN JOSE ST by 21 over New Mexico St - Spartans have won 17 of the 20 mtgs. Last mtg came back in '12 when SJSt won 47-7 (504-220). SJSt dropped to 2-2 last wk after losing at WMich 23-3 where they gained just 119 yds (52 yds on opening drive, -3 TO's). NMSt is 1-4 this ssn (lone win vs FCS tm) but are avg'g 387 ypg/25 ppg the L/4 gms incl throwing for 291 ypg. NMSt has all'd 13 sks on the ssn while SJSt had 9 sks in 4 gms. SJSt's offense is avg'g just 332 yds/18 pts this ssn & QB Starkel was inj'd last week. The Spartans are running for just 79 ypg (3.2). SJSt will be happy to return home after 3 straight road gms & we think they will bounce back in front of their home fans with a win, but NMSt has covered 2 gms as a 2+ TD dog TY & think they do it again here.

Washington by 10 over OREGON ST - After an 0-2 start to the season where they were held to just 17 til pts against Montana and Mich, the Huskies have gotten back on track the past 2 wks with a 49 pt victory over Ark St and a 7 point OT win LW over Cal. The Beavers meanwhile return to Corvallis following a surprising 45-27 victory over USC (QB Nolan 4 TD passes!), OSU has dropped the past 9 (3-6 ATS) against the Huskies (23 pt avg defeat) including a 27-21 loss LY where they

were held scoreless in the 2H. With the Beavers failing to cover 11 of their L/14 as a HD coming in, we're expecting UW to continue their recent success against OSU here.

CALIFORNIA by 3 over Washington St - It's been a rough couple of weeks for the Cougars who head into Berkeley following a 31 pt loss at home against the Trojans and an 11 point defeat on the road against the Utes. The Bears meanwhile had a late fumble in OT against the Huskies in a game that they had a 457-326 yard edge in (3-1 TO deficit). Cal has won 12 of the L/15 meetings with the Cougars including a 33-20 home win in '19 as a 7 pt dog. They are 0-10 as a HF dating back to '18 which includes an outright upset by Nevada to start this ssn.

Oregon by 5 over STANFORD - The Ducks continue to churn through their competition following an easy 22 pt victory LW in Eugene against Arizona where they took advantage of a 5-0 TO edge (UA 31-17 FD & 435-393 yd edges). The Cardinal meanwhile couldn't rebound from a slow start LW at home against the Bruins in the eventual 11 pt defeat (UCLA 24-11 FD & 455-360 yd edges. LY starting QB Mills was ruled out (Covid protocol) for Stanford in a 35-14 loss. While the visitor has covered 7 of the L/11 in this series and the Ducks have a bye week on the horizon, the Cardinal have a solid 6-3 ATS record as a HD under HC Shaw and should keep this one within a TD.

Central Michigan by 2 over MIAMI, OH - Miami has won 3 straight SU & ATS vs CM incl a 26-21 upset (+6) in the '19 MAC Champ gm. LTH ('16) MU trailed 14-13 2Q but won 37-17 (E). CM is 2-2 SU & ATS while MU is 1-3 SU & ATS. LW we have a 4★ Late Phone Play going against MU, as they were outgained 384-232 by Army allowing 6.1 ypc rush. LW CM after giving up a block punt for a td, trailed FIU 27-10 late 3Q as an 11' pt HF, but scored 21 unanswered, the GW td w/ 1:18 left. CM has a huge Off edge (#48-#106) avg 453 ypg vs FBS despite playing 2 SEC foes, while MU is avg just 283 ypg vs FBS. MU allowing 269 ypg & 5.8 ypc vs FBS while CM is avg 144 ypg rush (3.9 ypc). With MU's Off struggles we look for CM to prevail in a close hard fought matchup.

Kent St by 20 over Bowling Green - Play for the Anniversary Award, first met 1920. Kent St is 6-5 SU & 7-4 ATS s/10 incl winning L/3 SU & ATS (L/2 as DD Fav). LY KS never trailed but was 10-10 into 2Q before Flashes scored next 38 (38-10 HT) allowing a 62 yd td run w/ 41 left to only win 62-24 as a 20' AF BG is 4-0 ATS winning L/2 SU incl LW's 14-10 upset win over Minn as a 31 pt AD. Flashes are 1-3 SU & ATS but have played a much tougher schedule (#13-#80) incl then #6 TX A&M & #5 Iowa. LW at MD, KS lost 37-16 (+14) despite only being outgained 526-458 & had a 27-23 FD edge but had 2 td's called back by penalties. KS has huge Off edge (#19-#129) & thanks to BG's big win the line is cheap & we look for Flashes to show why they are the MAC East favorite.

Ucf by 21 over NAVY - UCF is 2-0 in the series and LTH in '17, the Knights (-7) using a late TD run to pull away for the road win, 31-21. After looking lifeless in B2B weeks, going 0-2 SU and ATS in blowout losses at home, Navy showed a pulse LW on the road vs. Houston (+19), still losing the yd and FD edge (-84, 16-20), but led 17-14 entering the 4Q before falling 28-20. Navy hasn't had QB Lavatani since the opener and have used a 2-QB system since. UCF has had an extra week to prepare Frosh QB Mikey Keene for his 1st start and we think UCF gets back on track with a 3 TD romp. SMU by 27 over Usf - The Bulls lead the series 3-2 but SMU was also a 4-0 headed into their last meeting in '19 on the road (-7) and won 48-21. The Mustangs are 3-1 ATS TY following an outright upset of TCU in Fort Worth (+9) 42-34. SMU was +149 yds w/ a 29-20 FD edge. USF fell behind 21-1 in the 1Q at #15 BYU (+23) LW and lost 35-27. The Bulls lone win was FCS Florida A&M (-21), 38-17. Mustang QB Tanner Mordecai is putting up videogame numbers (1,268, 71%, 20/5 in 4 gms) and USF is allowing 504 ypg. SMU is 15-7 ATS as HF since '15. We think USF gets pounded on again and lose by 4 scores.

OKLAHOMA ST by 1 over Baylor - Since 2014 BU has gone 5-2 SU against OSU and the Bears have covered 4 of the L/6 mtgs. LY these teams met in the ssn finale and OSU was up 28-0 at HT (347-52) and won 42-3 (608-156). BU is off to a 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS start and beat a ranked ISU tm last wk despite being -197 yds (98-yd KR TD). OSU is also 4-0 SU this ssn & just beat a ranked KSt tm last wk & both tms enter newly ranked. OSU's offense finally got rolling last wk as they put up 481 yds & face a BU D that all'd 479 yds to ISU last wk, but they are still holding foes to 90 ypg under their ssn avg. BU's rush attack has been a surprise this ssn (271, 6.5) but face an OSU run D that is all'g just 87 ypg (2.6) & they have 13 sks in 4 gms but BU's OL has all'd just 3 sks on 93 pass att. We feel like BU's D can keep them close with OSU & will call for the Cowboys to get a narrow home win.

GEORGIA by 15 over Arkansas - This is a top 10 SEC matchup after Ark has pulled upsets over TX & A&M. LY UGA started Dwan Mathis at QB (now at Temple) and trailed 7-5 at half. The Dawgs dominated the 2H after switching to Stetson Bennett and won 37-10 (-28). Not only did we win our Early Bird play (Every Monday, call 1-347-677-1700) on UGA LW but we also used the Dawgs as a 3★ LPS for an easy winner in their 62-0 romp over Vandy. UGA finished with 532-77 yd edge and had twice as many td's as Vandy had FD's. Ark held a 443-271 yd edge over A&M LW. They are holding foes 177 ypg below their avg but UGA is holding foes 182 ypg below their avg. While we really like Georgia, we also can't lay nearly 3 td's against the red-hot Hogs who are 4-0 ATS TY.

Ohio by 3 over AKRON - Ohio has won 12 of L/13 but Akron is 5-1 ATS the L/6. LY Ohio won 24-10 as a 27' pt HF as they won the TO battle 3-0. Akron had a 20-15 FD & 435-307 yd edges & only trailed 14-10 3Q. Bobcats are a shocking 0-4 SU & ATS incl a 28-26 loss to an FCS team as their offense is avg under 10 ppg vs FBS. LW at NW as a 14 pt AD they trailed 35-0 before scoring on a final play 55 yd td run. LW Akron led Ohio St 7-0 mid-1Q & lost 59-7 as a 48' pt AD but missed a FG & dropped a backdoor td late 4Q. With UA's starting QB injured vs Temple, backup DJ Irons has added a rush option element (56 gross rush vs OSU). Teams are both struggling but fairly evenly matched which has us taking the Zips & the inflated pts after an expected blowout loss.
