KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Oregon over WASHINGTON - This is the first Pac-12 matchup of teams 5-0 or better since 2004. The Ducks have outscored their foes by 40 ppg on the year (5-0 ATS) and rank #2 in the nation at 558 ypg while the Huskies have a 28 pt avg MOV (3-1-1 ATS) and are currently #1 in the FBS at 569 ypg. Oregon has the solid edge on defense, allowing just 256 ypg while UW has given up 365 and allowed 502 yds vs Cal 3 weeks ago. After dropping 3 straight (SU & ATS) from '18-'21, the Huskies (+12) went into Eugene and picked up a 37-34 upset win over the #6 ranked Ducks. While UW is also an impressive 7-2-1 ATS the L2Y as home chalk, the Ducks are on an 8-3 ATS run inside of the P12 and should earn their revenge (visitor is on a 3-0 SU/ATS run w/a 7 pt avg cover). We will take the better defense to win as our top play this week.

FORECAST: Oregon by 7

3★ OREGON ST over UCLA - The Beavers return home after a 12 pt road win in Berkeley where QB Uigalelei threw for 275 yds and 5 TD's. They now welcome a Bruins squad that got a huge defensive effort LW inside of the Rose Bowl where they held WSU to 318 yds under their snr average! In their most recent meeting back in '19, the Beavers (+6) went into Pasadena and delivered a 48-31 upset (21-0 lead after 1Q). While the Bruins are 9-4 SU (10-3 ATS) in this series s/'2000, they did struggle in their loan P12 road trip so far TY with Utah (-3) holding them to just 243 yds in the 14-7 victory. With OSU a dominant 15-1 SU/ATS inside of their home venue including a 21-7 (-4) win over that same Utes squad a few weeks ago, we have no issue leaning with the Beavers in this one.

FORECAST: OREGON ST by 13

3★ TCU over BYU - Former MW foes have met 11 times (TCU leads 6-5) and the last mtg was back in '11 where TCU (-13) won 38-28. BYU enters here off a bye & sit at 4-1 despite being -42 ypg while TCU enters here +105 ypg, however they had dropped the past 2 gms despite outgaining their opponents. LW against ISU, TCU was +45 yds but -4 TO's in a 27-14 loss BYU has struggled to get their ground game going (63, 2.3) and TCU has defended the run well this season (108, 3.0). After allowing Col to throw for 510 yds in the opener, TCU is all'g just 191 pass ypg (49%) and their pass D ranks #28. We'll call for TCU to protect home turf & win by 2 td's against a flawed BYU tm.

FORECAST: TCU by 14

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Auburn (+) over LSU - Last year Auburn led 17-0 but allowed a fumble return td and ended up losing 21-17 as 8 pt dogs. LSU is a tired team, playing their 7th straight week and their 4th straight vs an SEC foe with the last 3 being high scoring close affairs. Auburn is fresh off a bye and full of confidence after only losing by 7 to Georgia two weeks ago. Auburn has struggled to pass but LSU's young DB's have allowed 283 pass ypg. LSU is only #93 in pass D efficiency (61.2%, 15-6) while Auburn is #15 in pass D efficiency (60.1%, 5-6). Auburn has covered the last 4 meetings and the underdog is 7-0 ATS. The visitor is 8-1 ATS and 13 of the last 19 meetings have been decided by single-digits. This is a series of trends that all lead to one conclusion, War Eagle!

FORECAST: LSU by 5

2★ UNLV over NEVADA - Battle for Fremont Cannon. Nev has covered 3 straight and LY UNLV snapped a 2 gm SU losing streak, winning 27-22. Both teams are off a bye, but are trending in opposite directions as UNLV is 4-1 SU TY while Nev is 0-5 SU. Nev's D is allowing 511 ypg & their pass D ranks #133 and are allowing 326 ypg (76%) and face a UNLV offense that could get back QB Brumfield (CS) but bkp QB Maiava has played well since taking over. UNLV is avg'g 217 rush ypg and face a Nev rush D giving up 185 ypg (5.9). Nev has done little on offense this year, avg'g just 292 ypg and their QB's have a comb'd 2-5 ratio. Nev's OL has all'd 15 sks (9.3%) while UNLV has 14 sks (8.6%) & they are all'g just 117 rush ypg (3.4). UNLV is 5-0 ATS under 1st year HC Barry Odom, so there's no reason to go against them here!

FORECAST: UNlv by 15

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 11TH

Utep by 3 over FIU - FIU won 3 straight meetings from '15-'19 but last year UTEP had a 525-71 yd edge and won 40-6 (-14). The Panthers were tied 17-17 last week at NMSU but were outscored 17-0 in the 4Q. To make matters worse, true frosh QB Keyone "Lights Out" Jenkins left late with a concussion. FIU will likely turn to Haden Carlson who started the finale last year and threw for 414 yds but 4 int's vs MT. UTEP is desperate for a win after 4 straight losses. They are fresh off a bye and could get back QB Hardison who missed their 24-10 loss to LA Tech two weeks ago. The Miners are -39 ypg while FIU is -117. UTEP is a small favorite and we like the Miners by a fg.

NEW MEXICO ST by 1 over Sam Houston - First meeting. NMSU has alternated wins with losses each week. Last week they were tied 17-17 entering 4Q but pulled away to win 34-17 (-6) over FIU. The Aggies are +52 ypg but have only played our #130 schedule. SH is much better than their 0-5 record indicates. They are 4-1 ATS and were 3 td dogs last week at Liberty but only lost 21-16, reaching the Lib3 on their final drive. SH also led Jacksonville St 21-7 at half the week prior and just missed that upset, losing in OT after giving up a td and 2 pt conv with :13 left. SH is on a 12-1 run as a dog and they have played our #28 schedule. The Bearcats have the edge on defense and the offense has looked better the last two weeks so we will take the points.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 12TH

Smu by 12 over EAST CAROLINA - 1st meeting since '20 and both teams are off a bye. The home team is just 1-6 ATS in the series. SMU comes in at 3-2 SU with their only losses coming against P5 foes Okla and TCU. SMU is avg'g 36 ppg and allowing just 15 ppg against non-P5 FBS foes and outgaining those same foes 410 ypg to 300 ypg. ECU (1-4 SU, 2-3 ATS) has yet to beat an FBS team as their only win came against FCS Gardner-Webb. After shuffling QB's the first 4 gms, the Pirates settled on Alex Flinn vs Rice 2 weeks ago but he hit just 21-44 for 246 (0-1 ratio) and ECU was held to 277 total yds. ECU is just 2-4 (3-3 ATS) off a bye under Hou and SMU was 2-0 as a conf AD last year and is the more talented squad, so we like the Mustangs to cover vs an ECU team that's received spotty QB play so far.

West Virginia by 10 over HOUSTON - First meeting. UH HC Holgorsen faces his former school here (spent '11-'18 at WVU, went 61-41). UH and WVU are both coming off a bye, but are trending in opposite directions as WVU is off to a 4-1 SU/ATS start while UH is just 2-3 SU/ATS and have dropped 2 Big 12 gms by 23 pts to TCU and 21 pts to Tex Tech. UH's run D held Rice & Sam Hou to under 70 rush yds but against UTSA, TCU, Tex Tech they all'd 232 rush (5.7) and WVU run gm is avg'g 192 ypg (4.3) and their OL has all'd 7 sks in 5 gms. WVU also has the edge on defense (#32 vs #87) and are holding foes to 40 ypg under their average & have the #14 pass D, while Hou's defense is all'g foes to gain 31 ypg above their avg (#102). UH is just 2-6 ATS as a HD under Holgorsen & we like WVU to continue their SU/ATS win streak.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 13TH

MEMPHIS by 3 over Tulane - These teams have met 16 times since '02 and Memphis has won all 8 meetings here (6-2 ATS) during that period, although Tulane did cover LTH in '21 in a 33-28 (+6) loss. Both teams are off a bye and both enter at 4-1 with both teams' loss coming vs an SEC foe. Memphis (1-2-2 ATS) beat Boise 35-32 (-3) last time out and is now 19-4 SU (10-11-2 ATS) at home since '20. Memphis has allowed over 500 tl yds each of the last 2 weeks, including 542 in a 34-27 (+7) loss to Missouri a few weeks back. Tulane (2-3 ATS) has won 3 straight after a 37-20 (+8) home loss to Ole Miss in week 2 that was closer than the final would indicate. The Wave appear to have found a featured RB in rFr Makhi Hughes, who has topped the 80 yd mark 3 of the L4W, including a season-high

123 (5.6) vs UAB 2 weeks ago. The Tulane defense allowed 170 rush yds vs UAB after allowing just 63 rush ypg their previous 4 games. Tulane HC Fritz is 0-3 (1-2 SU) at Memphis and the Tigers are 4-1 ATS as a conf HD since '18 which has us liking Memphis to continue their winning ways at home. **Fresno St by 10 over UTAH ST** - Have not met since 2020 where Fresno (-10) led 28-16 HT and won 35-16. The previous meetings ('15, '16, '19) were all won and covered by Utah St. Fresno is off their 1st loss of the ssn, losing at WY 24-19 as they were held to a snn-low 324 yds. QB won 44-24 over CSU last wk where they trailed 17-0 1Q but then scored 37 unanswered pts & QB Legas threw for 387 yds & 4 td's. Fresno has the massive DEF edge in this game (#40 vs #128) as they are holding tms to 290 ypg/18 ppg while USU is allowing 433 ypg/35 ppg the L4 gms and their pass D ranks #81 & here face Fresno QB Keene who is hitting 68% with a 15-4 ratio. Meanwhile USU QB Legas faces a much tougher pass D here as Fresno ranks #28. USU is on a 2-4 ATS run as a MW dog and Fresno is +118 ypg/+15 ppg TY & we see them winning by DD's.

COLORADO by 17 over Stanford - The Buffs got back on track LW against the Sun Devils (GW 43-43 yd FG w/12 left, ASU 392-295 yd edge) following a 2-game losing skid against a pair of the P12's elite (36 pt loss to Oregon & 7 pt loss vs USC). They now return from Tempe to take on a well-rested Cardinal squad (off a bye) that hasn't won since their ssn opener (1-3 ATS, 23 pt avg defeat). The Buffs have won and covered 3 straight in the series (all as dogs) with each being decided by 5 pts or less. The last meeting occurred in '20 with Colorado (+8) getting the 35-32 road win. While the visitor is on a 4-1 SU/ATS run, the Cardinal have gone just 4-17 ATS vs conf foes the L3Y which doesn't bode well vs a Buffs team that can go all out with a bye on deck.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 14TH

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 7 over Kent St - This is the only MAC series that Flashes lead thanks to winning 6 of last 8 going 5-3 ATS. LTH KSU (+4) led 31-14 4Q but just 31-26 4Q before winning 34-26. Last met LY when EM won 31-24 as a 7' pt AD finishing with a 459-357 yd edge. Eagles are off their 4th straight win at home (2-2 ATS) beating Ball St 24-10 as a 2' pt HF despite being outgained 306-253. LW KS (+24) was tied 7-7 with Ohio late 2Q but trailed 42-10 early 4Q in a 42-17 loss. While both have bottom 10 offenses EM does have the edge on defense (#96#118). Kent St has failed to cover 3 straight despite being a DD dog of 14+ in each, but EM's cover LW was their first as a favorite in the last 9 in that role. EM has opened as a 10 pt HF, a role they have not covered in since 2019 and as they are avg'g just 259 ypg, so we will take the points here.

MARYLAND by 20 over Illinois - 3rd meeting. Maryland has won both previous matchups, but Illinois did cover in the last meeting in 2021. The Illini (2-4, 0-6 ATS) are off back-to-back conf losses in which they were outscored 64-26 and they were held to just 21 rush yds in their 20-7 (-3) home loss to Nebraska last week. Illinois' rush defense, which was a strength last year (100 ypg, 3.3) has turned into a weakness as they are allowing 192 rush ypg (4.4) vs Power 5 foes this year. Maryland played a great half plus of football at Ohio St last week as they were tied 10-10 at HT with 177-142 yardage edge and then took a 17-10 lead to the start of the 2H, but were then outscored 27-0 the rest of the way and the Terps were held to 10 tl yds in the 4Q. Maryland is on a 5-1 ATS run and has a bye on deck while the Illini haven't covered this year and have been outscored by 18 ppg on the road, so we'll take the Terps to cover a line that opened around 2 tds.

DUKE by 3 over Nc State - NCSU is 9-2 SU in this series but only 5-6 ATS and they haven't actually met once since '13. Riley Leonard is likely not playing after he suffered a high ankle injury late vs ND. The Blue Devils did get a bye week to rest and for a moment it looked like they'd upset the Irish when they led 14-13 but allowed a 95 yd/10 pt td drive. NCSU lost to that same ND team 45-24 (+7) but did only trail 24-17 4Q. NCSU turned to MJ Morris last week and all they did was put up a snn high 48 points, beating the Herd by a td (-6). While Morris did throw 4 td's, he also threw 3 int's and NCSU was outgained 419-401. Elko is 7-2 ATS vs ACC foes and Doeren is just 9-17-2 as an AD. With Leonard likely out we can't give Duke more than a 3 point lean which is right at the line.

Texas A&M by 1 over TENNESSEE - This is only the 3rd SEC meeting with both previous games won by A&M. Tenn is fresh off a bye after an impressive 41-20 (-12) win over South Carolina where they held a 477-333 yd edge. The Aggies are #4 in the FBS, holding foes 136 ypg below their average and held their first 5 foes to a snn low yds. The Vols are rushing for 231 (6.2) ypg and have allowed just 6 sacks but A&M may have the country's deepest Dline, allowing just 84 rush ypg (2.6) with 26 sacks (17.7%)! Last week the Aggies held Bama to 23 rush yds and had 6 sacks. Tenn's D has held foes 85 ypg below their avg (#16 in FBS) and has 22 sks (13.3%). The Vols have won 12 straight at home but Josh Heupel is 0-7 SU/ATS when his teams are held under 30 points and we think A&M has the defense to do just that so we will take the Aggies to pull the upset.

FLORIDA ST by 20 over Syracuse - FSU is 10-1 SU in this series and Cuse is 0-7 SU/2-5 ATS in Tallahassee. Last year FSU won 38-3 (-7) with a 420-160 yd edge in the JMA Wireless Dome. FSU is 5-0 though we haven't been as impressed with their last 3 performances. They escaped BC by 2, was outgained by 118 yds at Clem & led VTech 22-0 1Q but only led by 5 in the 2H before pulling away again. Cuse has been drubbed the last 2 weeks, losing by 17 at home to Clemson & last week they were smoked 40-7 (+9) and outgained 644-221 at NC. FSU has played a much tougher sked (#3 vs #111). The Orange have covered their last 4 games vs AP Top 10 teams and they did win at Purdue earlier this year. However, this is Cuse's 7th straight week playing while FSU had a bye 2 weeks ago. We are happy with this game near the opening line.

KENTUCKY by 5 over Missouri - Mizzou is just 1-7 SU/2-6 ATS in this series and the Under has hit in 8 of the last 11 mtgs (avg 46.2 ppg) but both teams have improved offenses this year. Both teams entered last week 5-0 but KY blowout at Georgia while Mizzou also felt their bubble burst when they lost 49-39 (+5) to LSU. Mizzou allowed 274 rush last week and faces the SEC's top RB in Ray Davis (653, 7.2). KY allowed 435 pass yds last week and faces Luther Burden who leads the FBS with 793 yds (14.7). QB Cook had his SEC record streak of 366 passes w/o an int end vs LSU. KY is only #85 in pass D Efficiency (67.6%, 10-6). We think KY is in better shape to bounce back and they did dominate FL two weeks ago at home, plus this is the first time all year that Mizzou will have to deal with a hostile environment.

MICHIGAN by 31 over Indiana - Michigan has won 19 of 20 in the series, but IU has covered 6 of 8, including last year when the Hoosiers were outgained 469-222 but still covered in a 31-10 (+22') home loss. Indiana is coming off a bye and it came at a good time as the Hoosiers are 2-3 (3-2 ATS) out of the gate and have yet to beat a Power 5 foe. IU fired their OC after their 44-17 (+14') loss at Maryland as the Hoosiers are averaging just 16 ppg & 278 ypg vs FBS foes. The Indiana defense limited Ohio St to 380 yds in the opener, but has allowed 456 ypg the last 3 gms, including 189 ypg on the ground. Michigan has cruised in their first 2 Big 10 games as they have outscored Nebraska and Minnesota 97-17 despite playing both on the road. They held the Gophers to 169 yds last week and are now allowing just 233 ypg. Michigan is 1-8-1 ATS as a 30+ fav since 2017 and has in-state rival Michigan St on deck and Indiana had an extra week to work with their new OC, so despite the recent B10 blowouts by Michigan we'll take the Hoosiers getting just under 5 tds.

VIRGINIA TECH by 5 over Wake Forest - VT is 5-2 SU/ATS in this series. The Hokies have looked better since turning to Baylor transfer Kyrion Drones at QB. They trailed FSU 22-0 last week but got within 5 in the 3Q and held on to cover as 24 pt dogs. WF only lost 17-12 (+21) at Clemson last week. The Deacons were held to 239 yds but held Clemson to a snn low 338. VT has ply'd a much tougher sked (#43 vs #128). The Hokies run D has allowed 195 (5.2) ypg but they've been better at home, allowing 134 (3.7) while WF has been held to 100 rush ypg (2.4) in two road games. VT's offense is more effective with Drones' dual threat ability and we like the home crowd to get the Hokies a winning edge.

OKLAHOMA ST +3' over Kansas

OKLAHOMA ST (+) over Kansas - From '15-'21 OKSt was 7-0 SU/5-0-2 ATS against KU, winning gms by 32 ppg but LY in Lawrence OKSt dropped their first gm to KU since '07, losing 37-16 (+1) as they all'd 554 yds incl 351 rush ypc (7.6) and were -4 TO's. OKSt is off a 29-21 outright upset LW at home (+11') vs KSt where they were +3 TO's incl a pick-6 and we picked up a 3★ LPS winner! KU is off to another good start TY, but starting QB Daniels has missed the L2 gms (back inj) and his status is ? for this game, but LW KU won 51-22 vs UCF as they were led by RB Neal ran for 154 yds (12.8 ypc!). KU's pass D is all'g 284 ypg (64%) in Big 12 play & overall their pass D ranks #71 and OKSt has finally settled on Bowman at QB, who threw for 235 yds LW. KU is just 4-10 ATS on the road under Leipold & are a Big 12 AF for the 1st time since 2009, and we'll take the Cowboys to pull another outright upset!

Ohio by 11 over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - Huskies are 4-2 SU since 2011 but just 2-4 ATS. Have been 3 outright upsets in the last 4 meetings including 2 straight. Last met LY when Ohio won 24-17 as a 3 pt HD despite being outgained 377-354. After avg just 286 ypg of offense their first 4 games, NIU has put up 444 & 571 the last 2 weeks. LW NIU rushed for 380 yds & 10.9 ypc thanks to RB Ontario Brown's career high 280 yds *21.5 ypg). They finished with a 571-253 yd edge cruising to a 55-14 win over Akron as a 5 pt AF. Bobcats are off a 42-17 win over Kent St as a 24' pt HF finishing with a 466-238 yd edge. Ohio has won 5 straight, covered 4 straight and has covered 9 straight regular season MAC games and NIU is 0-9 ATS at home so we go back to the Bobcats.

UTAH by 10 over California - Following a home defeat LW against the Beavers where they allowed 50+ pts for a 2nd time TY (1st time at home in the 7-yr Wilcox tenure), the Bears head into SLC for their 2nd P12 AG of the ssn (27 pt loss at UW a few wks back). The Utes meanwhile earned a much-needed bye after their 1st loss of the year against that very same OSU squad (Utah outgained 358-198 in 14 pt defeat). In their most recent meeting ('19), the Utes (-20') finished with 23-6 FD and 473-83 yd edge in a 35-0 victory. While Utah will more than likely get the win again this time (is this the wk QB Rising returns?), they do have contests with USC and Oregon on deck. The Bears meanwhile are 13-4 ATS as an AD and should stay within the spread in this one.

San Jose St by 12 over NEW MEXICO - As MW foes they have met just 4 times, and SJSJ is 3-1 SU/4-0 ATS but the last meeting was back in 2020 where SJSJ (-13') won 38-21. SJSJ is off to a 1-5 start after blowing 27-7 1H lead at Boise St last week where they were held to 109 yds 2H (319 yds 1H), but still have time get to a bowl, but it has to start here. NMex is off a bye and sit at 2-3. SJSJ has taken on the much tougher sked (#24/#110) and we'd expect QB Cordeiro to have a big game here vs a NMex pass D ranked #124 and he just threw for 325 yds LW vs a better Boise team. NMex can run the ball (178, 5.3) and face a SJSJ run D all'g 297 ypg (6.0) the L3 gms. However feel like SJSJ is much better than their record & we like them here by DD's.

AIR FORCE by 7 over Wyoming - Since 2014 WY is 5-3 SU/6-2 with 4 outright upsets incl last season where WY (+16') hosted AF and held them to 272 yds in a 17-14 upset win. AF is off a bye, while WY is playing for the 7th straight week. WY is off a big home win vs Fresno 24-19 & look to be a contender in the MW TY. WY HC Bohl has typically defended the AF option well, holding them to under 200 yds in 4 of the 8 mts and overall are all'g 213 rush ypg (3.9 ypc). AF has another strong defense TY & are holding tms to 92 ypg under their avg, but have faced the #132 sked while WY has faced the #46 sked. WY's run game improved w/ the return of RB Waylee as he has three 100+ yd gms & total has 540 yds (7.2 ypc!) in 4 gms, but he was banged up last wk (CS). While AF is one of the strongest MW tms TY, WY is a tough, physical team that will keep this game close & WY is 3-1 ATS as a DD MW dog since '21.

Boise St by 7 over COLORADO ST - As MW foes Boise is 12-0 SU and 9-3 ATS against CSU. LY Boise (-25') led 28-10 HT and won 49-10 (+344 yds) and LTH in '21 Boise (-2') trailed 16-7 HT but used a strong 2H comeback & won 28-19. Boise trailed 27-7 1H vs SJSJ but held them to 110 yds 2H and came back to win 35-27. Here Boise faces a CSU pass D ranked #128 and are all'g 320 pass ypg (7.4%) however, Boise's QB situation has been in flux the past couple weeks with both Green & Madsen sharing time. Boise's D is struggling TY as well, all'g 483 ypg vs FBS foes & their pass D ranks #118 and CSU QB Follower-Nicolosi is hitting 65% but had his worst gm of the ssn LW hitting 45% with a 0-3 ratio. Boise is off a big win and are still unbeaten in MW play, while CSU blew a 17-pt lead LW and gave up 639 yds. We'll take Boise by a td.

WASHINGTON ST by 17 over Arizona - The Cougars fell short of an upset of the Bruins LW in Pasadena where they were held to just 17 pts and 216 yds (4 TO's). They now welcome a Wildcats team that dropped a 3 OT contest a week ago in LA against the Trojans with bkp QB Fifita throwing for 303 yds and 5 TD's (AZ 506-365 yd edge). While the HT in this series is on a 4-1 SU/ATS run, the Cougars (-4) did go on the road a year ago and collect a 31-20 win despite the Wildcats finishing with a 441-354 yd edge (WSU +2 TO's). With the Cougars on an 11-1 ATS at home against FBS foes, Arizona could be in for a long day in the Palouse.

UTSA by 6 over Uab - These teams have met each of the past 6 seasons and UAB is 4-2 SU/ATS but UTSA has won the last 2, including a 44-38 (-1) win at UAB last year despite being outgained 553-494. UTSA got QB Harris back LW and the offense exploded for 49 pts and 495 yds in their 49-34 (-14) win at Temple which was their 1st AAC win. Harris hit 25-33 for 338 and 3 tds (no ints) and the D survived 65 pass att by Temple. UAB also secured their 1st ever AAC win with a decisive 56-35 (+3) home win over USF in which they put up 608 yds with 253 rush (5.3). QB Jacob Zeno is now hitting 76% with 12-5 ratio, but the D remains a concern as the 49ers have allowed over 440 yds to all 5 FBS foes. The home team is on an 0-4 ATS run and although UTSA is on a 18-4 SU run at home in the Alamodome, they are just just 9-13 ATS so we like this hot UAB offense getting over a td.

TEXAS ST by 21 over Ulm - As SBC foes TXSt is just 4-6 SU but 7-3 ATS incl covering the past 3 games. LY TXSt led 27-17 3Q but ULM came back to win 31-30 despite TXSt being +4 TO's. TXSt dropped a game to LA last wk 34-30 where they led 20-14 HT. ULM is of a 55-7 drubbing at home to SAIA where they were -339 yds. ULM's pass D ranks #132 and are allowing 284 ypg (7.1%) and face TXSt QB Finley who is hitting 73% and a 12-2 ratio, and RB Mahdi has 676 yds (8.0 ypc!) this ssn and face a ULM run D that is all'g 171 ypg (4.6) the L4 gms and ULM's defense overall has all'd 561 ypg/48 ppg the past 3 games. ULM is great as a home dog, but as a road dog under Bowden they are 4-10 ATS and are -189 ypg/-25 ppg in those road gms, so we'll ride with the Bobcats here by 3 td's.

WISCONSIN by 10 over Iowa - These teams have split the last 4 meetings, but WISC has won the last 3 in Madison (2-1 ATS) and has held Iowa under 160 td yds each of the last 2 games. The Hawkeyes are 5-1 (3-2-1 ATS) off a 20-14 (-2) win over Purdue, despite being held under 300 total yds for the 5th time in 6 games. Iowa's D limited Purdue to 96 rush yds (2.4) and had 6 sacks. QB Deacon Hill made his first career start and went 6-21 for just 110 yds, but RB Kaleb Johnson rushed for 134 (7.9) including a 67 yd td run on Iowa's 2nd possession. The Hawkeye defense remains one of the B10's best allowing 16 ppg with only 1 oppononet (Penn St) scoring over 16 pts. The Badgers are off a workmanlike 24-13 (-12) home win over Rutgers. The Badgers led 17-0 at HT with a 200-

119 yard edge, but allowed Rutgers to get the backdoor cover giving up a td with 4:07 left. Wisc rushed for 212 and are now averaging 204 rush ypg TY. Although it's only midseason, this one could very well decide the B10 West Champ and while we expect the Badgers to get the home win, we do think the opportunistic Hawkeyes will keep this one within the spread that opened at nearly 2 tds.

ALABAMA by 24 over Arkansas - Bama is 16-0 SU/9-6-1 ATS in this series with a 49-26 (-17) win last year. The Tide just won B2B on the road, beating Miss St 40-17 then overcame a 17-10 deficit to beat A&M 26-20 (-2). Ark has lost 4 straight games, with 3 coming by 7 points or less and are in a brutal stretch, playing their 4th straight away from home. Ark was +13 last week and led Ole Miss 20-17 4Q but gave up 10 pts in the last 8 minutes. Bama is +61 ypg and their D is holding foes 162 ypg below their avg (#1 in FBS). The Hogs do have mounting injuries and QB Jefferson took a beating vs A&M and Ole Miss. They have 4 of their last 5 games at home and winning those games are their best chance to get to a bowl while Bama is getting on a roll.

NORTH TEXAS by 10 over Temple - 1st meeting and this is the first AAC home game for UNT. The Mean Green fell to 2-3 SU/ATS with a 27-24 (-6) loss at Navy. UNT led 10-7 in the 2Q, but allowed a Navy td with :43 left in the half and never regained the lead. QB Chandler Rogers hit 22-32 for 267 (1-0 ratio), but was sacked 8 times! The UNT rush defense has been an issue as they allowed 331 (5.7) to Navy and are now allowing 259 (5.8) rush ypg. Temple finally got their offense untracked, but fell 49-34 (-14) at home to UTSA. QB EJ Warner threw for 472 and 5 tds (no ints), but it wasn't enough as the Owls allowed 495 total yds and have allowed 46 ppg the last 3 weeks. Temple is 0-13 SU (5-8 ATS) in AAC road games the last 3 seasons and North Texas is 3-0 as a single-digit favorite since '21, so we like the Mean Green by double-digits in this one.

Georgia by 41 over VANDERBILT - UGA is 5-0 SU/ATS. Their last 2 wins have come by a combined 117-0. Georgia's offense finally showed up last week. They put up 51 points and their 608 yds is their highest since '20! Vandy's D has allowed 54 ypg more than their foes avg. They have given up at least 36 points in each of their last 5 games, all losses. UGA is 16-9 as an SEC AF while Vandy is 5-20 as an SEC HD. Vandy is also 0-7 ATS this year. UGA always has the crowd edge in Nashville, so we will take the Dawgs by a large margin and the line feels cheap at -31' considering Vandy has lost the last 5 meetings by 40 ppg.

Kansas St by 3 over TEXAS TECH - KSt has won and covered the last 6 mts against TT despite being outgained in 4 of those 6 mts (KSt +7 TO's in L6 mts). KSt is off a 29-21 loss at Okla St (11' pt chalk) where they were outgained by 40 yds & were -3 TO's incl giving up a pick-6 and QB Howard threw 3 int's. TT picked up a road win LW over Baylor 39-14 where QB Morton hit 73% and RB Brooks ran for 170 yds. KSt is getting strong performances from their run game & overall are avg'g 203 rush ypg (5.3) but face a TT run D giving up just 126 (3.5). KSt QB Howard can get on track this week vs TT pass D ranked #77 and have allowed 335 and 324 pass yds in their L2 gms. After starting 0-2, TT has won 3 of 4 games and are back at home this week, but after a bad performance LW, we look for KSt to rebound and win on the road as they are on a 7-2 ATS run off a SU loss.

San Diego St by 7 over HAWAII - SDSSt has won the L3 mts vs UH, but the last 2 gms have been decided by 7 pts or less. Both teams enter this game off a bye and both sit at 2-4 on the season & SDSSt has lost 4 straight gms. SDSSt's usually strong defense is not performing up to its standard as they are allow 438 ypg/31 ppg and are giving up 38 ppg more than their foes allow (#108 FBS). However UH is running for just 59 ypg (2.3) and their OLine has allowed 25 sks (10.2%) and their pass attack (279 ypg, 64%) faces the #36 pass D. SDSSt's offense is avg'g just 325 ypg/19 ppg, as the rush attack is only putting up 142 ypg (4.0) and QB Mayden is hitting 61% (5-5 ratio) but have faced the much tougher sked & with them taking a step down in competition, we think SDSSt rebounds with a win & a cover here.

NOTRE DAME by 7 over Usc - USC had plenty of issues in their narrow 3 OT win vs the Wildcats with AZ finishing with a 506-365 yd edge (QB Williams 260 td yds & 4 TD's). They now head to South Bend to take on an Irish squad that suffered their 2nd loss of the ssn LW at Louisville thanks in part to 5 costly TO's including 3 int's from veteran QB Hartman (Cardinals 330-298 yd edge). With the distance between schools it's no surprise that the HT has gone an outstanding 8-1 SU/ATS including a 38-27 (-4) win by the Trojans a year ago in LA (USC 204 rush, 5.2). The clincher with our lean for the Irish is that USC has been a terrible AD over the years with just a 5-16 ATS mark!

TUESDAY OCTOBER 17TH

Middle Tennessee at LIBERTY - These two met in '21, Liberty was -19' and won 41-13. The Flames are 5-0, having won their first 4 by double-digits but last week needed a late stop to get by Sam Houston 21-16 (-21). The seat is getting hot for Rick Stockstill with MT off to a 1-5 start. MT led Jacksonville St 23-7 last week but allowed 38 consecutive points and lost 45-30 (-3). The Blue Raiders held a 563-401 yd edge but were plagued with 4 TO's and allowed 40, 27 & 17 yd td drives along with a fumble return. Liberty is +7 TO's on the season. Call 1-800-654-3448 to get our Tuesday Night Marquee for just \$12.

Wku at JACKSONVILLE ST - JSU has been trailing their last two games 23-7 and 21-7 at half yet won both and are 5-1 at presstime with a game vs Liberty the week prior. They are 3-0 SU in CUSA play despite being -98 ypg. WKU is 4-2 and -70 ypg. They've won their last two, beating MT by 21 and held off LT 35-28 after having a 28 pt lead at half. JSU is +11 TO's on the season but WKU leads the nation in forced TO's with 16 and they are fresh off a bye.

Southern Miss at SOUTH ALABAMA - These teams have met the last 3 years & SAIA is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS. LY SAIA (-7') led 27-17 late 4Q before SMiss tacked on a late FG and lost by 7. SAIA is off a 55-7 blowout win at ULM where they outgained them by 339 yds, while SMiss dropped their 5th straight game, losing to ODU 17-13. SAIA's defense is holding tms to 298 ypg the L4 gms and SMiss's offense has struggled with consistency, as they are putting up 356 ypg, but LW only only put up 276 yds vs ODU. SMiss has a strong pass rush (17 sks, 12.9%) and their pass D is allowing just 191 ypg (55%). SAIA overall has the big edge on offense (#39 vs #116) and defense (#33 vs #106).

4★ HOUSTON over New Orleans - This marks the 4th away contest in a 5-week span for the Saints who head into HOU after a 34-0 victory LW in Foxboro where we cashed a Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner on Under 39! The Texans on the other hand come in after suffering a narrow 21-19 (+2) defeat LW in ATL (HOU outgained 447-313). These 2 have met on 5 occasions all-time with the home team going a perfect 5-0 SU (4-1 ATS) and a 12 pt avg MOV. The most recent matchup was back in '19 with the Saints (-7) escaping with a 30-28 win with a GW 58-yd FG as time expired. With the Texans picking up covers in 6 of their last 8 prior to a bye, we'll call for that home squad to move to 6-0 in their all-time meetings. **FORECAST: HOUSTON by 7**

3★ San Francisco over CLEVELAND - The Browns return from their bye week looking to get back on track following an ugly home performance in Wk 4 against the Ravens where they were held to just 3 pts and 166 yds (QB Watson missed w/inj). The 49ers meanwhile moved to 5-0 on the ssn after a 32 pt home win against the Cowboys on SNF (QB Purdy 17-24-252-4-0). Their last meeting occurred in '19 with the 49ers (-5) grabbing the easy 31-3 victory as they held the Browns to just 9 FD's and 180 yards. While CLE is 10-4 ATS against the NFC, they have failed to cover 7 of their L/8 following a week off. That's not a good sign against a 49ers juggernaut that's on an 11-1-1 overall ATS run! **FORECAST: San Francisco by 13**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Washington over ATLANTA - Following their only HG in a 4-wk span last Thur against CHI where they were smacked around throughout (trailed 27-3 at HT, QB Howell 37-51-388-2-1, the Commanders travel South to take on a Falcons squad that got a GW 37-yd FG w/0:02 left against HOU After losing 6 straight from '06-'18, the Commanders have won in each of the past 2 ssn's including a 19-13 (-4) victory LY. With WAS also going a solid 6-2 ATS in recent away matchups and having some extra rest, we'll go ahead and give them a lean in this one as ATL has failed to cover 13 of their past 16 overall. **FORECAST: Washington by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

Denver at KANSAS CITY - Thursday - This is the 1st of 2 matchups in a 3-wk span between the Broncos and Chiefs. DEN's ugly ssn continued LW at home against the Jets in a 31-21 defeat (NYJ 407-308 yd edge). The Chiefs meanwhile hung on for a 7 pt win LW in MIN (QB Mahomes 281 pass yds & 2 TD). Following their OT win a year ago in Arrowhead, KC has now won 15 straight (10-5 ATS) with Patrick Mahomes going 11-0 all-time vs DEN (269 pass ypg, 66%, 18-8 ratio). While the Broncos have had some rough spread matchups dating back to the end of LY with failed covers in 7 of the past 8, laying too many points with the Chiefs inside of the AFC West is also risky as they've gone just 1-6 ATS. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

† Baltimore by 6 over Tennessee - London. After a pair of road trips against DIV foes CLE (all'd just 3 pts & 166 yds in a 25 pt victory) and PIT (3 costly TO's in a 7 pt loss, BAL led 10-3 middle 4Q), the Ravens (0-1 in London) head across the pond to take on a Titans squad (0-1 in London) who suffered their own DIV loss away from home LW against the Colts (IND 429-348 yd edge). The Ravens and Titans have played in 5 separate playoff matchups including their most recent meeting back in '20 where BAL (+3) picked up a 20-13 upset in Nashville (22-12 FD & 401-209 yd edges). While the Titans are a solid 17-7-1 ATS as a dog, the Ravens are starting to get back some of their key contributors from injury and should pick up the win in what could be a low-scoring affair.

Minnesota by 7 over CHICAGO - This marks the 1st of 3 AG's in a 4-wk span for the Vikings who head into the "Windy City" following a 7 pt home loss against the Chiefs where star WR Jefferson was lost in the 2H with inj (CS here). The Bears meanwhile return home with extra rest after earning their 1st win in 15 tries (WR Moore 230 rec yds & 3 TD, CHI 451-388 yd edge, led 27-3 at HT). The Vikings have swept their series against the Bears in each of the past 2 years. In their trip to Soldier Field a year ago, MIN (-7) finished with 28-13 FD and 482-259 yd edges in the 29-13 victory. With the Vikings also 19-10-1 ATS as away chalk, this could be another long day for the CHI faithful.

CINCINNATI by 6 over Seattle - The Bengals FINALLY put together a complete game LW on the road against the Cardinals with WR Chase pulling in 15 catches for 192 yds and 3 TD's in the 14 pt victory. They now return home to take on a Seahawks squad who is already heading East for the 3rd time TY (currently 2-0 ATS w/14 pt avg MOV). In their most recent meeting back in '19, the Seahawks (-9) would pick up a 21-20 win despite substantial FD (22-12) and yard (429-233) deficits (CIN 3 fumbles). The Seahawks have failed to win or cover the past 3 years following a bye wk including twice when they were listed as the favorite. With the Bengals going 8-2-1 ATS in recent HG's and 5-1-1 ATS against the NFC, we'll lean in their direction for this one.

JACKSONVILLE by 2 over Indianapolis - This marks the only "true" home matchup for the Jags in a 5-wk span as they return from a 2-wk trip in London where they picked up a pair of wins (29-18 FD & 474-388 yd edges in 5 pt victory over BUF) and have a pair of road trips to NO and PIT on deck. IND meanwhile is on the road for the only time in a 5-wk span following a 23-16 (+2) home win against the Titans where bkp QB Minshew saw extended action (11-14-155-0-0) for rookie QB Richardson (shldr inj). In their Wk 1 matchup TY, the Jags (-4) overcame a 4 pt deficit in the 4Q in the eventual 31-21 victory (JAX 342-280 yd edge). With IND playing tough in the opener along with the Jags being potentially jet-lagged from their return from England, we're calling for the visitor to stay within a FG in this one (JAX just 2-11 ATS as a HF!).

MIAMI by 16 over Carolina - Following a rough trip to BUF 2 weeks ago where they suffered their 1st loss of the ssn (28 pt defeat!), the Dolphins had no issue getting back on track LW in "South Beach" against a struggling Giants squad that's decimated with inj's (MIA 524-268 yd edge). The Panthers meanwhile are just 3-7 ATS as a NDIV AD following an 18 pt loss in Ford Field against the Lions where they had a 3-0 TO deficit (CAR 26-23 FD edge). After winning 2 straight ('13 & '17) against the Dolphins, the Panthers struggled in their last contest ('21) with MIA (+1) finishing with 22-10 FD and 315-198 yards edges in the 33-10 victory. While CAR is an impressive 5-1 ATS prior to a bye, backing them on the road against an impressive MIA squad that's 12-4 ATS as a HF would be way too risky.

Detroit by 6 over TAMPA BAY - After another impressive home victory a wk ago against CAR where QB Goff threw for 236 yds and 3 TD's, DET heads South having covered 7 of their L/10 AG's. Standing in their way is a TB team that's off to a surprising 3-1 start and well-rested following an early ssn bye wk (QB Mayfield 221 ypg, 70%, 7-2 ratio). The Bucs have won the past 2 meetings against DET (at Ford Field) in dominating fashion with a 85-24 combined score (DET held to just 186 yds in '20 defeat). They have however failed to cover 4 of their L/5 following a wk off. With DET an outstanding 13-2 ATS overall, we have no issue giving them the lean in this one.

LAS VEGAS by 7 over New England - After a rough home outing against the Saints where they were held to just 8 FD's and 156 yds in a shutout defeat, the Patriots (all'd 69 unanswered pts & have gone 10 straight quarters w/o a TD) head to the desert to take on a familiar face in HC Josh McDaniels who spent a combined 13 years as the OC in NE. The Raiders are back at home on short rest after a MNF meeting with the Packers. Following a dominant run in this series where they won 6 straight (5-1 ATS) from '05-'20 (16 pt avg MOV), the Patriots shockingly fell 30-24 (+1) a year ago with the Raiders returning a dramatic 48-yd fumble for a TD as time expired. With NE going a dismal 2-11 ATS in recent contests as a dog, we expect McDaniels to cool off his "hot seat" for at least a week with a solid victory (NE on a 1-8 overall ATS run).

LA RAMS by 9 over Arizona - Following a 14 pt loss in the desert against the Bengals where they had a 27-15 FD deficit and were forced into 3 TO's, the Cardinals are back on the DIV road for the next 2 contests (loss at SF in Wk 4, at SEA next wk). The Rams are inside of their home venue for the 2nd of 3 consec weeks after a 23-14 loss against the Eagles where they had 28-17 FD and 454-249 yd disadvantages. While the Rams have won 11 of their L/13 matchups with the Cardinals (11-2 ATS), they did drop their home meeting a year ago with ARZ (+3) in a battle of backup QB's (both teams with less than 300 yds). Although ARZ has gone 11-4 ATS as an AD, they have failed to cover 8 of their past 9 inside of the NFC West.

Philadelphia by 10 over NY JETS - The Jets used a trip to "Mile High" where pretty much everyone wins lately to end a 3-game losing skid against the Broncos (RB Hall 177 rush yds). They now welcome an undefeated Eagles squad that picked up a 9 pt road victory a week ago against the Rams with 28-17 FD and 454-249 yd edges. The Eagles have yet to drop a game all-time against the Jets with a perfect 12-0 SU mark and a 12 pt avg MOV. While the Jets did play relatively well in their most recent HG against the Chiefs (3 pt loss as 8 pt dog), they have failed to cover 11 of their past 15 meetings with the NFC (PHI 6-2 ATS vs AFC foes).

NY Giants at BUFFALO - SNF - Rematch of SB XXV (1990) where BUF K Scott Norwood missed "Wide Right" on his GW FG attempt. The Giants were steamrolled once again a week ago against the Dolphins with QB Jones leaving in the 4Q w/a neck inj (NYG outgained 524-268). BUF meanwhile returns home following a trip to London where they scored a pair of late TD's in a 5 pt loss to JAX (QB Allen 373 tti yds & 3 TD). In their most recent meeting back in '19, the Bills (-2) collected a 28-14 victory. While the schedule has been extremely daunting so far TY for the banged-up Giants with DAL, SF, SEA and MIA all in their rearview mirror, obviously a trip to BUF on SNF won't be any easier. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Dallas at LA CHARGERS - MNF - A well-rested Chargers squad returns from bye week with the expectation that star RB Ekeler will be returning from an injury that kept him out since the latter part of the opener. The Cowboys meanwhile are back in Cali for a 2nd straight week after a rough matchup against the unbeaten 49ers who finished with 25-8 FD and 421-197 yd edges in the 32 pt victory (QB Prescott 3 int's!). After dropping 3 straight from '09-'17 (0-3 ATS, 11 pt avg loss), the Cowboys picked up a 20-17 (+3) win in '21 with a GW 56-yd FG as time expired. While DAL is 4-0 ATS prior to their own bye week and will have a potential home field edge with a big amount of Cowboys fans making the journey to LA, keep in mind that the Chargers are 6-3-1 ATS as a NDIV HD.
