## KEY SELECTIONS

**4★ WEST VIRGINIA over Kansas** - Both teams are off a bye. As B12 foes WVU is 7-1 SU vs KU, but just 4-4 ATS. LY WVU (-4) hosted KU and despite getting outgained (417-394) they forced 2 TO's and barely covered, winning 29-24. Jayhawks frosh QB Daniels (foot inj) could miss this gm. RB Pooka Williams battled an inj early on & only has 175 rush (4.4) this ssn. KU's offense only put up 193 yds & 7 pts in their last game & were outgained by 400 yards by OKSt! WVU also faced OKSt this season & held a 353-342 yd edge but lost by 14. WVU looks to have an improved run game, led by RB Leddie Brown (320, 5.1) this ssn & faces a KU defense that has all'd 228 rush ypg (4.7). WVU is allowing just 268 ypg & 19 ppg, and in their last game held Baylor to 256 yds in a 27-21 2OT win. WVU won their only game as a Big 12 favorite LY under Brown, and it was vs Kansas. KU has looked awful this year & the last time WVU played we used them as our first 5★ free to all subscribers so naturally we go back to the Mountaineers!

**FORECAST: WEST VIRGINIA by 34**

**3★ UAB over Wku** - UAB is out for revenge after losing LY 20-13 (-3). The Blazers were +76 yds and +6 FD's but QB Johnston threw 3 costly int's. WKU may be switching QB's after getting crushed 38-14 (+7) vs Marshall last week. Pigrome only threw for 61 yards, rushed for 28 and lost 2 fumbles. Backup QB Kevaris Thomas led 2 H td drives after the game was already decided. UAB had a scheduled bye and their 21-13 home win over UTSA looks a lot more impressive after the RoadRunners performed well at BYU last week. UAB actually held a +129 yd edge vs UTSA and the RoadRunners were only outgained by 111 yds vs BYU. The 'Toppers have now had 3 poor performances where they were held under 300 yards and UAB's experienced defense has only allowed 296 ypg vs non-P5 foes & even held Miami 88 yds below their avg. The Blazers are 20-0 SU/14-4-2 ATS at home and WKU has failed to cover 6 straight.

**3★ Texas A&M over MISSISSIPPI ST** - Miss St had won 3 straight from '16-'18 but last year A&M jumped to a 42-17 3Q lead and won by 18 as 10' pt chalk. Last week we used OVER 59 as our 4.5★ Totals Game of the Month, getting an easy winner and the Aggies pulled a 41-38 (+6) home upset over Florida. QB Mond threw for 338 yds and 3 td's and RB Spiller had 174 yds and 2 td's. We also went against Miss St as our 4★ Top LPS and were delighted by the Bulldogs 6 int's in their 24-2 (+2) loss vs Kentucky. QB Leach seems to insist on fitting a square peg into a round hole at the moment and QB Costello isn't helping with 9 int's in 3 games. A&M held a +141 yd edge vs Florida last week. The Bulldogs win against LSU is looking much less impressive and until we see their offense show some improvement we can't possibly back them. Fisher is 2-0 as an AF at A&M and we will go with the Aggies by 2 td's.

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ Southern Miss over UTEP** - SM has won 5 straight mtgs and are 3-1 ATS. SM actually held a 519-294 yd edge though. The Golden Eagles had their game against FAU cancelled last week. UTEP played LA Tech much closer than expected, only losing 21-17 (+14'). QB Hardison only has a 2-3 ratio and UTEP has been held under 300 yards in 3 of their last 4 games. SM had a lot of turmoil to start the season but did seem to get things right in their last game beating North Texas 41-31 and put up a season high 437 yards. UTEP is playing much better than expected but this is still a rebuilding team and SMiss is still experienced with a veteran QB. New HC Walden will look to continue the Golden Eagles momentum and we think the early 3' point line is low so our lean is clearly with SM.

## OTHER GAMES

### WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 14TH

**Coastal Carolina at LOUISIANA** - Game was orig set to be played on Oct. 17, then it was moved up to Oct 10th, but now is being played here due to the hurricane last week. Last ssn LA went to Coastal on a Thursday night and won 48-7 (564-236 yd edge, 30-14 FD edge). LA last played Sept 26th while Coastal hosted Ark St in their last gm 11 days ago and put up 539 yds in a 52-23 win. Coastal is getting great play from QB McCall, who threw for 322 yds (69%, 4-1) vs Ark St and for the year he has 728 pass yds (67%, 9-1) and has ran for 139 yds. LA is 3-0 on the ssn, but their 2 SBC wins are by a combined 5 pts as they needed OT to get past GSt and a 53-yd GW FG to win vs GS. LA RB Mitchell has ran for 210 yds (8.8) this ssn, but overall LA has ran for 169 ypg (5.1) after they avg'd 257 yds (6.3) on the ground last ssn. Coastal's DEF has all'd 365 ypg this ssn and have recorded 11 sks. CCar is an impressive 5-1 ATS as an away dog under HC Chadwell. LA has had their season interrupted by positive tests & postponed games while Coastal hasn't really had those disruptions.

### THURSDAY OCTOBER 15TH

**Georgia St at ARKANSAS ST** - As SBC foes Ark St is 5-1 SU, but each team has 3 wins ATS. LY GSt (+6) hosted Ark St and were -2 in TO's but put up a school record 722 yds in a 52-38 outright upset. GSt comes in off a bye, and 2 weeks ago put up 485 yds in a 49-29 win vs ECU. Ark St just played 5 days ago (50-27 win vs Central Ark) and comes in on short rest. Ark St did hold KSt to 374 yds, but in their other 2 FBS gms, they all'd over 500 total yds & 215 rush yds in both. Despite losing the key pieces from their run game LY, GSt is running for 235 ypg (4.9) with RB Coates (263, 4.6) leading the way. RS frosh QB Brown also a threat to run. Ark St still has a strong pass attack & two talented QB's splitting snaps. The Red Wolves are avg'g 343 pass yds & have several talented WR's that will give GSt fits. Ark St is an impressive 15-4 ATS as home chalk vs SBC foes under HC Anderson, but they are on short rest taking on a GSt team with extra rest.

### FRIDAY OCTOBER 16TH

**Smu at TULANE** - Tulane is coming off a 49-31 loss to Houston last Thur where they went up 24-7 (scored 21 pts off 3 early TO's), but outgained were 476-211 and lost 49-31, while SMU is off a bye week. SMU is losing 2 big players on offense as WR Roberson (22 rec, 474 yds, 5 td) and RB McDaniel (297, 5.0) expected to be out awhile. Tulane's top RB Spears (274, 7.4) is OFY. Tulane is starting true frosh QB Pratt & he was just 11/25 for 141 yds last week. Tulane is avg'g 242 rush ypg (5.3) but were held to just 70 rush yds (1.6) vs Houston, but SMU's rush defense has all'd 202 rush ypg (4.8) when facing FBS foes this season. SMU's pass offense is avg'g 395 yds vs FBS foes and they go up against a Tulane pass DEF that just gave up 319 pass yds last week. Both DEF's have gotten to the QB this year as SMU has 11 sks through 4 gms (8 sks in L/2 gms) while Tulane has 13 sks in their 4 gms. SMU has won the L/5 meetings SU and are 4-1 ATS. SMU went 3-0 ATS LY as single-digit AAC chalk, but Tulane is 4-0 ATS the L4Y as a home dog in AAC play.

**Houston at BYU** - Teams met in 2013 and '14 with BYU winning both games by a comb'd 9 points. BYU played their closest game of the year last week, winning 27-20 vs UTSA (4★ LP winner on the UNDER 63) while Houston played their first game last Thur and went down 24-7 (3 early TO's) but came back to win 49-31 (476-211) despite being -5 in TO's. BYU won't have the advantage of the elevation, this is their first road game since Sept. 7th at Navy. BYU's offense through 4 gms is avg'g 557 yds and 44 pts. QB Zach Wilson has improved his draft stock a ton this season, throwing for 1,241 yds (81%, 8-1) and has also ran for 6 td's. BYU's deep & talented defense (2 to 3 deep at every position) is holding foes to 251 ypg and 11 ppg! Houston has 4 gms of film on BYU while they have only 1 game of film on Houston. If Houston is -5 TO's they likely won't be in this game, but this could be BYU's toughest test yet. BYU crushed Navy as away chalk this season, but were 0-5 ATS as road chalk last year & got tested last week vs UTSA.

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## SATURDAY OCTOBER 17TH

**VIRGINIA TECH by 14 over Boston College** - BC has won the L/2 SU and is 7-2 ATS with 3 straight covers against the Hokies. VTech is out for revenge after losing last year's opener on the road 35-28 (-4'). VT is coming off a loss after falling behind 21-0 1Q at NCar last week. Down 35-14 at half, they finally turned to last year's starter Hendon Hooker who had missed their first 2 games due to lack of preparation from Covid. Hooker got the Hokies within 42-37 but their defense got decimated by NCar's run game, allowing 399 (9.3). BC has had back-to-back impressive performances by staying close with NCar and beating Pitt last week 31-30 (+6) in OT. QB Jurkovec has topped 300 yards in all 3 ACC games and he's got a 5-0 ratio in the last 2. VT had 13 sacks in their first 2 games combined and only allowed 139 (3.5) so they should rebound against an Eagles run game that hasn't topped 87 rush yds this season (1.9) and has given up 16 sacks! The Hokies are only 5-11 as chalk and BC is on an 18-5-1 ATS run as a dog but this is a value play on the Hokies who have been decimated on defense with Covid issues and they were 6-2 SU/ATS when Hooker started last year.

**MIAMI, FL by 10 over Pittsburgh** - Miami has dominated their former Big East rival with a 12-2 SU/10-4 ATS record. The Panthers are out for revenge from LY's 16-12 (-4) loss when the 'Canes got the GW td with :58 left. Pitt has lost their last 2 games vs NCSt & BC by 1 point each. Pitt tied the game on a 58 yard fg by Alex Kessman then lost the game when he missed the PAT in OT. The Panthers only allowed 264 and held their first 3 foes to their season low yards, but they've allowed 398 & 388 in their last 2 with multiple defensive starters missing. Miami was shutdown last week at Clemson in a 42-17 (+15) loss. The 'Canes were held to 210 yards and QB King only completed 43% for 121 yds and 2 int's. The dog has covered 5 of the last 6 in this series and Pitt should feel more comfortable in the underdog role for the first time this season. Narduzzi is 10-4 as an AD vs ACC foes but we can't give the Panthers much of a lean with the 'Canes hungry coming off a loss.

**TEMPLE by 14 over Usf** - Home team is 4-2 ATS, but have failed to cover the L/2 mtgs. LY Temple (-1) travelled to USF and held the Bulls to just 286 yds & 7 pts and got a fumble return TD to help Temple win 17-7. Temple just played their first game last week, losing 31-29 to Navy (missd 2-pt conv late) while USF already has four games in the books this season. However, USF is 1-3 (only win vs FCS team) and are avg'g 307 yds & have scored just 31 pts in 3 games vs FBS foes. Temple usually has a strong defense (haven't allowed more than 381 ypg the L6Y) but only return 4 str's and lose 7 of the top 9 k'rs. But they did hold Navy to 299 yds (251 rush). Temple does have firepower back on OFF as QB Russo is back along with RB Davis (936, 4.8, 8 td LY) and the top 2 WR's. Last week the OFF showed little signs of rust, putting up 407 yds. USF is just 1-5-1 ATS as an AAC dog the L2Y while Temple has had success as AAC chalk, going 14-4-1 ATS the L5Y. Despite USF having the 3 GUB edge, we don't really see that being a factor and have no issue leaning Temple by 2 TD's.

**Navy by 3 over EAST CAROLINA** - Since 2006 these teams have met 7 times, with Navy going 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS. The home team is just 2-5 ATS. Navy has won those 6 gms by an avg of 28 pts & covered their 5 ATS wins by an avg of 29 pts vs ECU. Navy has avg'd 419 rush yds vs ECU in their L7 games. However this is not the same Navy team of past years. They are falling behind in games, which forces Navy to get away from the option and into their passing game more. Navy has all'd 9 sks on 40 pass attempts (23%)! Navy this ssn has only ran for 166 ypg (3.5) but ran for 251 last week vs Temple and now face an ECU run defense that has all'd 188 ypg (4.8) through 3 games. Navy's DEF returned 7 str's this season, but that unit has allowed 443 ypg & 37 ppg on the season. ECU's offense looked good last week vs USF, as QB Ahlers threw for 222 yds & 3 td and ECU put up 432 yds & 44 pts. Navy is 8-3 ATS as AAC road chalk since joining the conf, while ECU is just 10-16 ATS as an AAC dog the L5Y. However, with how poorly Navy is playing this season it is tough to trust them, even against a team they have dominated in the past.

**NC STATE by 8 over Duke** - These instate rivals haven't met since 2013. The dog is 7-2 in this series and the home team is just 4-6 SU/2-8 ATS. Duke finally got in the win column last week, beating Syracuse 38-24 (-2). The Blue Devils dominated the game far more than the final score indicates, finishing with 645-286 yd & 36-11 FD edges but finished -4 TO's for the 3rd time this season! We've won 2★ selections on these pages on the Wolfpack edge of the last 2 weeks and even upgraded to a 4★ LPS last week when NCSt beat UVA 38-17 as 7' pt dogs. QB Leary has a 7-1 ratio. Duke has 18 sacks this season including 6 last week and their DE's are the strength of the defense. NCSt has allowed 0 sacks despite missing RT Witt for the 2nd straight game. The 'Pack are chalk for the first time this season and Doeren is only 5-9 as an ACC HF but we've had a lot of success with NCSt this year and we don't mind going back to them considering they are only laying 4 points at home.

**WAKE FOREST by 3 over Virginia** - WF has won the last 3 meetings but they haven't met since 2016 which was Mendenhall's first year at UVA. The Cavaliers were 7' pt chalk last week vs NCSt but fell behind 24-7 and ultimately lost by 3 td's. QB Armstrong threw 2 int's early before leaving with an inj. Bkp Lindell Stone came in and did throw for 3 td's. WF hasn't played an FBS foe in nearly a month and that was against the same Wolfpack squad, a 45-42 (E) loss. WF has had time to fix the issues on their Oline which caused them to allow 12 sacks in their first 2 games. UVA had 7 sacks in their first 2 but were held sackless by NCSt last week. The Deacons are 4-0 under Clawson was they are dogs of 3 or less so we give a lean to Wake Forest.

**North Carolina by 17 over FLORIDA ST** - NCar has won the last 2 SU & ATS against the 'Noles but they haven't met since '16. The Tar Heels offense came alive last week against VTech, putting up 656 yards! QB Howell had a slid performance but it was the Oline and RB's that dominated the effort, rushing for 399 yds and 9.3 ypc! The Heels might have the best RB duo in the country with Carter who had 214 last week and Williams had 169. FSU performed much better with Jordan Travis at QB, only losing 42-26 (+21). Travis finished with 204 pass & 96 rush and the 'Noles actually led 17-14 2Q. FSU is allowing 503 ypg vs FBS foes and ND ran for 353 (8.4). Now they face NC's vaunted rush attack and Howell could have a field day against FSU who is giving up 69%. FSU is 0-6 ATS at home. HC Brown won't take the once dominant 'Noles lightly and we think laying 10 points is a short price for the talented Tar Heels

**SYRACUSE by 3 over Liberty** - These teams faced each other LY and Cuse held the Flames to 234 yds & ZERO points in a 24-0 shutout. Last week Cuse forced 4 Duke TO's but still allowed 645 yds (Duke had 36-11 FD edge) and lost 38-24. In their game against ULM, Liberty got 21 pts from ST's last week in a 40-7 rout (400-198 yd edge for Liberty). Liberty's pass rush could have a big game as they face a Cuse Oline that has given up 21 sks through 4 gms! Liberty QB Willis was back last week & he totaled 264 yards (177 pas, 87 rush). He and RB Mack (361, 6.1) face a Cuse defense that just all'd 365 rush yds to Duke last week, and for the season are giving up 231 rush ypg. Liberty does come in with just 1-4 ATS record against P5 foes, and they are in a rare position of being road chalk vs a P5 team. LY Liberty (-7) was in that role at Rutgers and lost outright. While we were have been impressed with Liberty, we'll lean with the Orange at home, who will probably feel disrespected about being a home dog to a team that just joined the FBS in 2018.

**Clemson by 38 over GEORGIA TECH** - Clemson is dominating this series of late, winning 5 straight and 4-0-1 ATS including LTH when we won our Sept 5★ with the Tigers winning 49-21 (-16). The Jackets enter off an upset win over Louisville 46-27 (+5) but the final score is extremely deceiving. GT trailed 21-7 2Q, was outgained 471-450 but they capitalized on 3 UL fumbles and converted for 21 points. They also tacked on a late td after UL was SOD at their own 18. Clemson has had their usual slow start but they woke up just in time to crush Miami 42-17 (-15) last week, finishing with a +340 yd edge. The Tigers are +216 ypg while GT is +4. QB Lawrence has a 10-0 ratio. QB Sims has a 5-8 ratio and faces his toughest test with a Clemson D that just stifled D'Erig King. We think Clemson will force the turnover prone Sims to make mistakes which will turn this into a blowout. Clemson is on a 16-4 ATS run vs ACC foes and we think it's time to jump back on the Tigers bandwagon.

**TENNESSEE by 10 over Kentucky** - Tenn has dominated this series with a 33-2 SU/26-9 ATS record. The Vols pulled a road upset last year, winning 17-13 (+1) after trailing 13-3 at half and got a goal line stand on KY's final poss. Tenn is off a 44-21 (+12) loss at UGA. The Vols actually led 21-17 at half but they turned the ball over 3 times in the 2H and had just 1 first down on their first 6 possessions which led to the route. We won our 4★ top LPS on Kentucky in last week's 24-2 (-2) win over Miss St. The 'Cats had offensive issues of their own, finishing with 157 yards but the defense held Miss St's air raid to 275 yds and had 6 int's! We can't blame the Vols too much for last week's loss since UGA might have the nation's top defense and their win against MO looks more impressive after the Tigers beat LSU. We also can't help but be concerned about KY's offense after LW's performance. Tenn is still on an 8-3 ATS run and we go with the series history on the Vols here.

**Texas St by 4 over SOUTH ALABAMA** - TXSt holds a 3-2 SU/ATS lead. TXSt is off game vs Troy, where they fell behind 23-3 by HT and lost 37-17 (outgained 488-254, out FD'd 26-15). SA has not played since Sept. 24th against UAB where they lost 42-10 (315-509) at home. TXSt's OFF is improved from LY as they are putting up 379 ypg & 30 ppg, but were held to 254 yds last week. QB McBride (held to 93 pass yds last wk) faces a SA DEF that has all'd 200+ yd pass gms & the TXSt run game has put up 5 straight 100+ yd rush games this ssn (avg'g 149 rush yds & only had 3 gms over 100+ rush all of '19). TXSt's OLine has given up 15 sks in 5 gms but SA's pass rush only has 4 sks on the season. Sala has only been SBC chalk 1 time under HC Campbell & it was a 41-31 win (Sala -9) over TXSt back in '18. TXSt was just 3-7 ATS LY as a dog, but are 2-1 in that role and we don't mind putting a small lean on them despite their down performance from a week ago.

**Mississippi by 7 over ARKANSAS** - Two new SEC head coaches meet for the first time. Arkansas is 6-1 SU/ATS and there have been 5 upsets in the last 7 mtgs. Ole Miss went stride for stride with Bama last week until the Tide pulled away late and won 63-48. The Rebels put up 647 yards on the vaunted Bama defense and their 48 pts was the most the Tide have given up vs an unranked team since 1936! QB Corral has topped 300 yds in all 3 games and has a 9-1 ratio. Arkansas nearly pulled their 2nd straight upset as DD Dogs last week in their 30-28 (+14) loss at Auburn. QB Franks threw for 318 yards and 4 td's. The Rebels have put up the most yds that all 3 of their foes have allowed this season (196 ypg more than foes allow!) but have also allowed all 3 foes to put up season high yards (267 ypg more than their foes allow on avg!). We normally prefer the better defense but with the lack of crowd noise and explosive offenses dominating this year we will go with the Rebels by a td.

**Cincinnati by 1 over TULSA** - Both teams are off an actual bye week. LY Tulsa did have the yard edge (377-317) and the FD edge (23-18) but UC forced 5 TO's and won 24-13 at home. UC last played USF two wks ago and held the Bulls to 291 yds in a 28-7 win, while Tulsa snapped UCF's 21-game home win streak 2 wks ago in a 34-26 win. UC's OFF is only avg a pedestrian 332 yds and 26 pts against FBS foes this season, but their DEF is holding FBS foes to 284 ypg & 9 ppg. Tulsa lost their top RB for the season (ACL inj) but are still averaging 139 rush ypg. They do face a Cincy run DEF that held USF to 83 yds in their last game. Tulsa QB Smith was held to under 50% last year vs Cincy (2 int's) and this season Cincy is allowing opposing QB's to hit just 52%. Tulsa did hold Oklahoma St to just 16 pts & 277 yds and recorded 6 sks (OSU QB left 1Q) in their opener, but last week gave up 455 yds (330 pass yds) to a talented UCF offense. Tulsa has been great as an underdog of late, going 7-2 ATS as a dog the L2Y, and Cincy is just 2-4-1 ATS the L2Y as a AAC favorite. We'll put a small lean on Cincy, but expect Tulsa to keep this game close & possibly put another AAC upset.

**Ucf by 7 over MEMPHIS** - Since 2005 UCF has dominated this series, going 13-0 SU but just 7-5-1 ATS. These 2 teams did not meet last season, but met 4 times the previous 2 ssn's including twice in the AAC title game. Both teams are off an actual bye week. In their last game Memphis fell behind SMU 24-3 in the 2Q, but came back to tie the game before losing on a late FG. UCF is off 34-26 loss to Tulsa (21-game home win streak snapped) where they were held to just 3 pts in the 2H. UCF is averaging 582 yds and 42 pts, but they've given up 456 ypg including 212 rush ypg. Despite being off nearly a month, the Memphis OFF looked very good vs SMU, putting up 585 yds. UCF is just 2-8 ATS the L2Y as AAC chalk, but with UCF opening as just 2 pt chalk we'll lean with the team that has won the L/13 mtgs SU as we feel like they can win this game by a TD.

**Army by 18 over UTSA** - First meeting was last season. Army (-17) ran for 340 yds (6.2) but needed a late 4Q TD to get cover, winning 31-13. Army is off a 14-9 win vs The Citadel, as both option teams put up a comb'd 446 yds. UTSA was the first team to hang with BYU this season, as they put up 359 yards in a 27-20 loss on the road. UTSA's run defense has improved from last season, as they are allowing 153 ypg (4.2) but the Army option is playing well this season as they are putting up 310 rush ypg (5.5). UTSA QB Harris played a bit last week, and looks like he'll be the starter here. LY vs Army he hit 74% of his passes for 187 yds (0-1 ratio). UTSA only ran for 72 yds last week vs a talented BYU defense & now face an Army run defense that is only giving up 83 ypg (2.8). UTSA is just 3-6 ATS the L3Y as a home dog & are 6-11 ATS the L3Y as a DD dog. Army recruits heavily out of Texas and they traditionally play well in the Lone Star state. We expect a similar outcome to the meeting LY and will lean with the Black Knights.



**UNDERDOG PLAY OF THE WEEK**

Over 38 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 38 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years including one outright winner this season! Here is This week's Underdog Play:

**SOUTH CAROLINA +3 over Auburn**

**SOUTH CAROLINA over Auburn** - Auburn is 10-1-1 SU in this series and they're on a 5-2 ATS run vs the Gamecocks. We picked up 3★ winners on both Power Sweep and LPS (also Early Bird winner, given out free on Mondays, call 1-347-677-1700) with South Carolina crushing Vanderbilt 41-7 (-13'). The Gamecocks finished with a 485-249 yard edge. Aub was fortunate to come away a winner last week against Arkansas. The Tigers did lead 17-0 2Q but fell behind and was nearly derailed on their final possession over a controversial call when QB Nix dropped a snap then spiked the ball backwards. Aub is -92 ypg on the season while SC is +58. Gamecocks RB Harris had 171 yards last week and the Gamecocks defense held Florida to a ssn low 348 yards 2 weeks ago. Muschamp is 14-8 as a dog with 9 outright upsets and Auburn was fortunate to come away with a last week so we will call for the Gamecocks to win outright! **FORECAST: SOUTH CAROLINA by 3**

**NOTRE DAME by 10 over Louisville** - Last year Louisville was an 18 point underdog in Satterfield's first game as HC. The Cardinals ultimately lost 35-17 but they were only outgained by 40 yards and were down just 21-14 at half. Notre Dame comes off a 42-26 (-21) win over Florida St. Louisville enters off a deceiving 46-27 (-5) loss at Georgia Tech where they led 21-7 2Q, finished with 471-450 yard & 24-19 FD edges but RB's Hall & Hawkins lost 3 fumbles which GT turned into 21 points. UL is 1-3 SU/ATS but they are +39 ypg. ND had trouble stopping mobile QB Travis and Cunningham is a similar QB but with much more experience. The Cardinals have talented skill players at QB, RB and WR and if they can avoid the turnover issues that has plagued them (-9 TO's) then they are capable of keeping this closer than expected.

**FLORIDA by 10 over Lsu** - Florida was one of the few teams that truly challenged LSU last year, tied in the 3Q and threw an int in the EZ in the 4Q of their 42-28 (+13') loss. We've picked up B2B Top Totals wins on Florida including last week, using the OVER 59 as our 4.5★ Totals GOM in the Gators 41-38 loss at A&M. LSU had their home game moved to Missouri last week and for the 2nd time in 3 weeks they lost as double-digit chalk, 45-41 (-14'). The Tigers allowed 586 yds against a fr QB making his first career start. Now LSU faces Kyle Trask who has a 14-1 ratio and Florida avg 42 ppg and 464 ypg. The Gators are allowing 66% and 331 pass ypg while LSU allows 63% and 381 pass ypg. Florida will have some home edge with Mullen calling for a full stadium but our lean is with the underdog Tigers who bounced back well off their first loss and should do so here too.

**MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 9 over North Texas** - MT is 7-4 SU/8-3 ATS in this series. Last year The Blue Raiders tied the game with :28 left but gave up a long KR and NT got a GW fg on the final play. Last week we said we didn't think Stockstill would go 0-5 and we were correct with MT pulled a 31-28 (+6') upset at FIU. MT held a 404-328 yd edge. We also said NT would finally play a clean game and beat Charlotte, that we were wrong about. NT fell behind 21-7 at half despite the yards being even, missing 2 fg's and getting SOD at the UC. QB Aune threw for 382 yds and 3 td's but NT was once again missing RB Adayway and only mustered 97 (3.6) rushing. MT only avg 342 ypg while NT allows 579 ypg. NT is on a 4-21 ATS run and MT is 10-4 ATS vs CUSA foes at home.

**CHARLOTTE by 9 over FIU** - As CUSA foes FIU is 5-0 SU against Charlotte, and have won the L/2 meetings ATS. Charlotte's offense woke up last week against N.Texas, as they put up 599 yds & 49 pts. QB Reynolds looked healthy in that game, as he threw for 290 yds & 2 td's. FIU played another close game, as they fell to Mid Tenn by 3 pts (threw INT late 4Q to end game). Through 2 gms FIU has given up over 400 yds in both games & Charlotte's offense looked to get on track last week. FIU used 3 different QB's who combined to hit just 46%. Will Healy has the 49ers playing well and FIU is still trying to figure things out so we will give a slight lean to the home chalk here.

**Marshall by 7 over LOUISIANA TECH** - Last year LT entered the game leading CUSA West but their starting QB & top WR were both suspended and the Bulldogs lost 31-10 (+6'). Marshall enters 3-0 after crushing WKU 38-14 (-7) last week. RB Knox topped 100 for the 2nd straight game and Marshall jumped to a 38-0 lead before giving up 2 late td's in garbage time. LT held off a vastly improved UTEP squad for a 21-17 (-14') home win. The Bulldogs were held to just 210 yards, their least since 2013. QB Luke Anthony does have a 10-2 ratio but only 2 td's in his last 2 games and RB Henderson who topped 1,000 yds last year hasn't topped 100 yet this year. MU has the edge on defense but the Herd only avg 362 vs 2 FBS foes so the edge on offense could go to LT. Holtz prefers the underdog role, going 19-9-1 since his 2nd year while Holiday is only 11-22 as chalk.

**MISSOURI by 28 over Vanderbilt** - Mizzou is out for revenge after losing 21-14 as 21 pt chalk last year. The Tigers had won 3 straight prior and the home team is 4-1 SU/3-2 ATS. We went against Vandy as a 3★ key selection and a LPS as well in their 41-7 (+13) loss at home vs Scar last week. The 'Dores only had 56 players available and were outgained 485-249. QB Seals only has a 3-4 ratio and Vandy's season high is just 266 yards. Mizzou put up 586 yards in their 45-41 upset win over LSU. QB Bazalak made his first career start and threw for 406 yds w/a 4-0 ratio. MO finished +107 yds against the same team that Vandy lost 41-7 against and was outgained by 232 yds. There isn't much good we can say about Vandy while Mizzou seems to be improving under new HC Drinkwitz and they've got the edge in all 3 phases so we will call for MO to win by 4 td's. Vandy is 8-17 as a dog.

**ALABAMA by 4 over Georgia** - Hard to believe but this is the Dawgs first time playing in Tuscaloosa since 2007, Saban's first year at Bama. Bama has won the last 5 meetings but Georgia covered the last 2 which were the '18 SEC Title gm & the '19 Nat'l Title gm. They last met in the regular season back in '15 & Bama was actually the dog & won 38-10 (+1'). The Tide enter after playing in a wild 63-48 (-23) affair against Ole Miss. Saban improved to 21-0 vs former assistants and faces another one here in Kirby Smart. Bama put up 723 yds last week, with Mac Jones throwing for 417. Georgia actually trailed 21-17 at half last week in their 44-21 (-12') win over Tennessee. The Dawgs pass rush dominated the 2nd half, creating 3 TO's and a SOD on Tenn's side of the field. Georgia's defense is only allowing 237 ypg while Bama's allows 437 ypg. Bama is 18-9-1 as an SEC HF but Smart is 7-3 as a dog. We only have a slight lean on the underdog Dawgs.

**GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 30 over UMass** - These teams actually met in the FCS title game back in 1998! As FBS foes they last met in 2018, and GS (-2) hosted UMass and the game was tied 10-10 in the 2Q, but GS pulled away in the 2H to win 34-13 (488-323). GS is off a bye and was supposed to play App St on Wed, but that game was cancelled and this game was added late last week. This is the first game for UMass and are under 2nd year HC Walt Bell. The Minutemen bring back 14 st's and have much more size & overall talent on both sides of the ball. GS last played vs ULM, and barely won 35-30 (stopped ULM on the 1-yd line). Against 2 FBS foes the GS defense is allowing 492 ypg & 25 ppg. UMass did allow 299 rush ypg (6.5) LY and against Army's option they gave up 448 rush yds (6.4). GS finally had their most of their guys back vs ULM and their offense ran for 340 yds (6.4). UMass is just 1-9-1 ATS the L2Y as an away dog, while GS is 7-2 ATS the L3Y as a home favorite.

**4★ MINNESOTA over Atlanta** - Following yet another rough home performance against the Panthers to remain winless on the ssn (CAR 437-369 yd edge), the Falcons head to MIN on just a 7-18 ATS run in matchups against NDIV foes. The Vikings meanwhile blew a 13-0 HT lead over the Seahawks in a 1 pt defeat (SEA GW TD pass w/:15 left, MIN 449-314 yd edge). The Vikings have won and covered 4 in a row in this series including a 28-12 home win a year ago in the '19 opener (MIN 11 pt avg MOV). **3★ NEW ENGLAND over Denver** - This game was orig schedule for LW before continued positive Covid tests by NE moved it back to here. The Patriots return to action after a MNF loss against KC where they were without the services of QB Newton due to Covid. The Broncos meanwhile picked up their 1st win of 2020 the previous Thur against the Jets with undrafted QB Rypien hitting 19-31-242-2-3 in his 1st career start. The Patriots have dominated this series dating back to 2011 with a 7-1 SU/ATS mark (only DEN win came in '15 AFC Championship). The most recent matchup was back in '17 where NE (-7) picked up a dominating 41-16 victory at "Mile High". Although DEN has covered 11 of their L/16 coming in overall, Belichick always dominates QB's making their 1st career start in Foxboro (Lock could be back here after missing the L/2 w/inj). **The Patriots cashed as our NFL Game of the Month back in September, could we go back to them this weekend?**

## OTHER SELECTIONS

**2★ TAMPA BAY over Green Bay** - This marks the only HG in a 4-week span for the Bucs who head into action with extra rest following a Thur loss against the Bears (TB 339-243 yd edge). The Packers meanwhile return to action following a bye and sitting at a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS so far in 2020 with a 13 pt avg MOV. The Packers have won 3 consecutive contests in this series (2-1 ATS) including a 26-20 (-2) win inside of Lambeau back in '17 (QB Rodgers & Brady are 1-1 all-time in head-to-head meetings). GB has however failed to cover 4 of their L/5 when returning from bye. We're taking the dog in this one.

## OTHER PLAYS

**CAROLINA by 6 over Chicago** - The Panthers extended their winning streak to 3 in a row LW in ATL behind a 313 yd, 2 TD effort from QB Bridgewater. The Bears meanwhile head to Charlotte on extra rest after erasing a 10+ pt deficit for the 3rd time this ssn to knock off the Bucs 20-19 (TB 339-243 yd edge). The Panthers have dropped 4 of the L/5 in this series including a 17-3 loss at Soldier Field back in '17 where they finished with dominant FD (20-5) and yard (293-153) edges but were done in by 75 yd FR and 76 IR TD's by CHI S Jackson. With the Bears on just a 6-11 ATS run coming in and CAR getting the outright upset over ARZ (+3) in their last home matchup, we'll be leaning in their direction this weekend.

**Detroit by 6 over JACKSONVILLE** - Following a pair of road trips that included a 16 pt defeat a week ago against the Texans where they had a 486-364 yd disadvantage (QB Minshew 301 pass yds, 2 TD), the Jaguars return home to take on a well-rested Lions squad who return from an early bye week. The Lions have picked up SU/ATS victories in the past 2 meetings including a 26-19 (-6) win at Ford Field back in '16. With the Lions covering 7 of their L/8 when returning from bye and JAX getting destroyed in their last home matchup against MIA (18 pt loss as 3 pt chalk), we're siding with the visitor.

**TENNESSEE by 1 over Houston** - The Texans FINALLY got into the win column a week ago against the Jags (QB Watson 359 pass yds, 3 TD) in the first game under interim HC Romeo Crennel who took over for the fired Bill O'Brien. They now head to Nashville to take on a Titans squad that saw their matchup against BUF shifted to Tue due to more Covid breakouts. The Texans and Titans have split their 2-game series in each of the past 4 years with TEN picking up the Wk 17 meeting a year ago in HOU (35-14, Texans resting starters). While the Titans have posted a solid 8-4 ATS mark as DIV home chalk, laying too many points could be dangerous as their 2020 victories have come by just 1, 2 and 3 pts.

**NY GIANTS by 1 over Washington** - This marks the only road contest for WAS over a 5-wk span as they head to MetLife following a 20 pt home loss to the Rams where we picked up a Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner on the "Under 46". The Giants meanwhile are back at home following a 2-game road trip that included a narrow 3 pt loss LW in DAL. The Giants have won and covered 10 of the L/14 in this series dating back to 2013 including a perfect 2-0 SU/ATS mark LY (24-3 win at home LY, **NFL GOM Winner!**). Despite that impressive mark in this rivalry, the Giants have failed to cover 5 of their L/6 DIV HG's.

**PITTSBURGH by 7 over Cleveland** - The Steelers finish up an extended homestand here against the Browns with their last road trip coming all the way back in Wk 1 (Wk 4 trip to Nashville postponed). PIT remained undefeated on the year following a 9 pt home win over the Eagles where rookie WR Claypool had 4 tti TD's. The Browns meanwhile are sitting at 4-1 for the 1st time since 1994 following a 9 pt win of their own over the Colts (385-308 yd edge). The Steelers have dominated this series dating back to '04 with a 27-4-1 SU (18-14 ATS) that includes a 20-13 (+2) win late LY in Heinz Field. In fact, the Steelers went a perfect 3-0 ATS a ssn ago in home matchups inside of the AFC North. With CLE failing to cover 20 of their L/31 vs DIV foes including 2 ATS losses already TY, we're riding with the home team here.

**Baltimore by 10 over PHILADELPHIA** - While the Eagles were able to get into the win column for the 1st time a few weeks ago in SF, they were unable to hold onto that momentum LW against the Steelers in Heinz Field (9 pt loss, PIT 367-336 yd edge). They now return to an empty home stadium to take on a Ravens squad that picked up a 24 pt victory against AFC North rival CIN a week ago (BAL 17-12 FD & 332-205 yd edges). The Ravens and Eagles have split the L/4 matchups in this series with BAL (-5) squeaking out a 27-26 home win back in '16 (PHI TD w/:04 left, went for 2 and failed). With BAL having covered 6 of their L/8 as an AF coming in and PHI's 2-8 ATS mark when listed as a NDIV HD, we'll give the visitor a DD edge in this one.

**INDIANAPOLIS by 14 over Cincinnati** - Following a rough outing in BAL where they were held to just 3 pts, 12 FD's and 205 yds in a 24 pt loss, the schedule doesn't get any easier for the Bengals as they head to IND to take on the NFL's #1 total defense (all g just 266 ypg). The Colts saw their 3-gm win streak snapped LW in CLE thanks in part to 2 more int's thrown by QB Rivers (CLE 385-308 yd edge). The Bengals have come out victorious in 4 of the L/5 meetings against the Colts including an 11 pt victory in the '18 opener (CIN scored 24 unanswered pts in 2H). Despite the recent success and a solid 4-1-1 ATS run, we're backing the Colts in this one as they've gone a perfect 7-0 ATS prior to a bye.
