KEY SELECTIONS

4★ UNLV over Colorado St - UNLV has dropped their L/4 mtgs to CSU both SU/ATS, but have not faced the Rams since 2019. CSU is off an incredible comeback where they won 31-30 vs Boise St despite being down 30-10 with 4 min left 4Q. UNLV beat rival Nev 45-27 where we picked up a 3★ LP & 2★ PS winner! UNLV QB Maiaava was 19-24 for 259 yds & 2 td. CSU's defense is struggling, as they are all g 301 pass ypg (72%) and a 15-6 ratio and rank #124 in our pass D rankings. CSU is also allowing 203 rush ypg (4.6) the L/4 gms and here face a UNLV offense that is led by a strong run game (224, 5.3) including putting up 291 rush (6.1) the L/3 gms! UNLV's D does stop the run well (129, 3.7) but have given up yds in the pass game (284 ypg, 58%). QB Fowler-Nicolosi is hitting 65% but has an 14-11 ratio and UNLV does have 9 int's on the ssn. With the line currently at a td we will lean with the Rebels by over 2 td's as they are now a perfect 6-0 ATS on the season! **FORECAST: UNLV by 16**

3★ FLORIDA ST over Duke - Duke is still looking for their first series win against FSU (0-21 SU) and are 0-7-1 ATS since '05. The Blue Devils were without QB Riley Leonard last week and beat NCSt 24-3 (-3). Duke only had 12 FD's with two td's coming on long plays (69 yd pass, 83 yd run). RFR QB Henry Belin started and threw for just 107 yds and only had 4 completions. FSU dominated Syracuse last week 41-3 (-18) and finished with a 535-261 yd edge. The 'Noles are holding foes 63 ypg below their avg (#27 in FBS) while Duke is holding foes 50 ypg below their avg (#30 in FBS). FSU has a slight edge on offense but if Leonard doesn't play that edge increases significantly. FSU is +85 ypg while Duke is +89 ypg but FSU has played the tougher sked (#5 vs #75). We have doubts that Leonard will return for this game so we are giving the 'Noles a big bump here! **FORECAST: FLORIDA ST by 24**

3★ Coastal Carolina over Arkansas St - Coastal has won the L/2 gms vs Ark St 52-20 in '21 and 52-23 in '20. Ark St comes in off a bye week while Coastal is off a upset win at App St where QB McCall threw for a career-high 373 yds. In that gm Coastal went back to running some option-like offense, a system that QB McCall thrived in under former HC Chadwell. Here Coastal faces our #131 defense that is allowing 518 ypg/37 ppg vs SBC foes and the Ark St pass D ranks #127 as they are all g 267 ypg (70%). CC has the #47 offense (Ark St #103) and Ark St's 3 wins are vs FCS Stony Brook, SMiss (1-5) and UMass (1-6) and that win vs App St may have turned CC's ssn around, so we'll take the Chants by over 2 td's. **FORECAST: Coastal Carolina by 18**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Eastern Michigan (+) over NORTHERN ILLINOIS - Huskies are 19-3 SU but just 12-10 ATS vs the Eagles. LY game was tied 7-7 1Q but NIU (+3) dominated the rest of the way outscoring WM 32-3. EM is off a 28-14 win over Kent St as an 8 pt HF benefitting from returning the opening inside kick for a td as they were outgained 343-218. After opening the season with an upset of BC, NIU struggled losing 4 straight. They seem to have turned their season around winning their last 2 and covering their last 3. LW they upset then MAC East co-leader Ohio ending the Bobcats 5 game winning streak. NIU (+5) won 23-13 finishing with a 302-254 yd edge. NIU has opened as a 12 pt favorite but are 0-7 as a HF since LY while EM is 18-2 as a MAC road dog since '16! That has us taking the Eagles and the points. **FORECAST: NORTHERN ILLINOIS by 6**

2★ ARKANSAS over Mississippi St - Last year Miss St won 40-17 (-9) though Ark did put up the most yards Miss St allowed all season (483). This is Ark's first home game since 9/16 when the beat BYU. They have played four straight away from home. Last week at Bama they were down 24-6 (+19) and had just 4 FD's. They were forced into 5 straight 3&out's but got going late and only lost 24-21. Miss St is fresh off a bye. Two weeks ago QB Rogers and RB Marks were banged up in their 41-28 (-21) win over WMich. Miss St has failed to cover all 5 games vs FBS foes and are -20 ypg this year. Ark is -30 ypg but do have close losses to LSU. Ole Miss and Bama, all on the road! We think the Hogs win this game but are concerned that Miss St is the fresher team and it's hard to lay 7 points with a 2-5 team so we are cutting our lean off just under 2 td's. **FORECAST: ARKANSAS by 13**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 18th

SAM HOUSTON by 5 over FIU - SH is still looking for their first win since moving up to the FBS but they've been competitive, losing 4 of 6 by 14 points or less. All six of their previous opponents have a winning record. Last week they were down 27-0 at half to New Mexico St but outscored the Aggies 13-0 in the 2H. FIU may be w/o QB Jenkins who was hurt late in their loss to UTEP. This is only Sam Houston's 2nd home game this year! They led Jax St 21-7 and outgained them by 42 yards. SH is holding foes 12 ypg below their avg (#62 in FBS) while FIU is allowing foes to put up 46 ypg more than their avg (#116). This is the first time SH has been a favorite all year and the home crowd should be excited to see them get their first ever FBS and CUSA win.

UTEP by 3 over New Mexico St - UTEP has won 7 of the last 10 in the Battle of I-10. Last year UTEP won 20-13 and they are on a 7-4-2 ATS run in the series. QB Cade McConnell got his first career start last week vs FIU. The Miners led 21-0 1Q with McConnell throwing 2 td's. Fortunately the defenses settled in and we still cashed our Wednesday Marquee on Under 43' as UTEP won 27-14. WR Kelly Akharaiyi had 223 yds and 2 td's. He was hurt late but didn't appear to be serious. NMSt led SH 27-0 at half last week and won 27-13 (-3). Pavia has a 14-5 ratio this year while UTEP has only allowed a 7-3 ratio and is #74 in our pass D rankings. HC Dimel still says this is his best team despite their 2-5 record and we think UTEP is the more physical team so they get the call.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 19th

James Madison by 6 over MARSHALL - 4th mtg all-time. LY JMU was w/o their starting QB at home vs MU and were held to 247 yds in 26-12 loss. MU is off a 41-24 loss at GSt despite being just -17 yds as they had a punt blk'd for td. JMU got to 6-0 on the ssn after beating GStHrn 41-13 despite being just +16 yds & -5 FD's (+3 TO's). JMU's pass D allows 310 ypg but Marshall's offense leans on their run game (156, 4.1) and RB Ali (641, 5.2, 11 td) but are facing a JMU run defense allowing just 43 ypg (1.5 ypc!!) and their DLine has 26 sks (10.3%). Marshall's run D is allowing 222 (6.7) the L/4 gms but their pass D ranks #17 and face JMU QB McCloud who is hitting 64% with a 14-3 ratio. We'll take the team with the stronger defense (#44 vs #104) and ST's (#28 vs #96) to win the game.

TULSA by 3 over Rice - 1st meeting since '13 when both schools were members of CUSA. Both teams enter this off a bye and both are off SU losses. Rice lost 38-31 (-10) at home to UConn 2 weeks ago, despite outgaining the Huskies 474-319. The Owls turned the ball over 4 times, including a fumble that was returned for a td. Rice QB Daniels has thrown for 1,831 (64%) with a 15-5 ratio, but the Owls are averaging just 49 rush ypg vs FBS foes. The Rice defense has shown improvement the last 2 weeks as they have allowed 355 ypg after allowing 499 ypg the previous 3 against FBS foes. Tulsa is on a 2-0-1 ATS run and fell 20-17 (-3) at FAU in their most recent outing. After missing the majority of the season starting QB Braylon Braxton came on in relief and led a 80 yd td drive to pull the Hurricane within a fg with 5 mins left. Tulsa is 2-1 SU at home this year and Rice has yet to win on the road, so we'll take the home team by a fg.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 20th

Smu by 21 over TEMPLE - 1st meeting since 2020 when SMU won 47-23 (-17) at Temple. The Mustangs (4-2, 3-3) are off a 31-10 (-11) road win at ECU last Thursday night, but the final is misleading. After jumping out to a 14-0 lead in the 1Q, SMU only led 14-10 at HT and was held scoreless in the 2nd & 3rd quarters but got a pick-6 in the 4Q to pull away. They did hold the Pirates

to 294 ttl yds and have allowed 313 ypg to AAC foes. The Mustangs came into the averaging 178 (4.7) rush ypg, but were held to just 58 (2.5) vs ECU. Temple (2-5, 1-6 ATS) is off a 45-14 (+6) loss at North Texas without starting QB Warner (check status) and has lost 3 straight and has allowed at least 41 pts four games in a row while allowing 525 ypg over that span. SMU has large edges on offense (#39-#118) and defense (#37-#128) and Temple is on a 0-4 ATS run, so we like the Mustangs to get their run game back on track and cover the line that opened over 2 tds.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 21st

Pittsburgh by 6 over WAKE FOREST - Rematch of the '21 ACC Title Game which Pitt won 45-21 (-3). Pitt had a dream situation last week, off a bye playing Louisville off a huge upset over Notre Dame. We called for the upset on these pages and Pitt won 38-21 (+7)! WF returns home after 3 straight losses. They were outgained 462-262 at VTech last week in a 30-13 (+1) loss. QB Griffis was benched in the 1H and backup Michael Kern threw for 166 and 0 int's but did lose 2 fumbles. Pitt was +3 TO's last week and actually outgained 444-288 and they are -31 FD's in their last 2 games. However, their D is still holding foes 65 ypg below their average. The Panthers have new life and Narduzzi is 8-5 ATS off an outright upset and 14-4 if an AF. Normally we don't like taking a QB in his first road start but WF isn't exactly a hostile environment and Veilleux didn't turn the ball over last week.

OHIO ST by 3 over Penn St - Ohio St has won 10 of 11 in the series and Penn St hasn't won in Columbus s/'11, but has covered 3 straight here and 6 of 7 overall. PSU (6-0 SU/ATS) is off a 63-0 (-42) win over UMass that featured 2 punt return tds by Daequan Hardy and the PSU defense held UMass to just 109 total yds and have held their last 3 foes to 175 total yds or less. QB Drew Allar has thrown for 1,092 (65%) and has yet to throw and int (9-0 ratio). The Buckeyes come in at 6-0 as well (3-2-1 ATS) and are on a 3-0-1 ATS run after their 41-7 (-19) win at Purdue. OSU scored on their 1st drive and never looked back as they led 20-0 at HT with a 269-120 yardage edge. Ohio St played without leading rusher Tre'Veyon Henderson (295, 6.7) and #2 WR Emeka Egbuka (both expected back here) but still managed to put up 486 as QB Kyle McCord threw for 276 and 3 tds and now has thrown 11 tds to just 1 int. Penn St comes in with our #1 defense while the the Buckeyes are #2. The Nittany Lions are #133 in explosive plays (over 20 yds) so while that prevents us from calling for the outright upset, we do like Penn St getting over a fg.

Clemson by 4 over MIAMI, FL - Clemson has won all 4 ACC meetings by 37 ppg including a 40-10 (-19) win last year. The Tigers are fresh off a bye but were very disappointing the week prior, only beating WF 17-12 (-21). Miami is -7 TO's in the last two weeks, losing in ridiculous fashion to GTEch then last week led NC 17-14 at half then opened the 2H with a fumble/int/punt/SOG and lost 41-31 (-3). Miami has the edge on offense avg 114 ypg more than their foes allow on avg while Clemson has the edge on defense, holding foes 96 ypg below their avg. Clemson has played a far tougher sked (#43 vs #109) and should have beat Florida St earlier this year. Miami did beat A&M at home earlier this year. Cristobal is 0-5 ATS at home at Miami while Clemson is 12-7-1 as an ACC AF since '18. We will take the better defense by over a fg.

NORTH CAROLINA by 17 over Virginia - Virginia is 5-1 ATS in this series and only lost 31-28 (+7) last year. The Cavaliers have the situation edge here coming off a bye while NC is off a huge win over Miami. The Tar Heels are 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS and +142 ypg this season. Drake Maye has an 8-0 ratio in his last 3 games. We cashed a 3★ FCS winner two weeks ago in Virginia's only win when they beat Will & Mary 27-13 (-7). Despite UVA's 1-5 record they are only -31 ypg and three of their losses were by 3 points or less. This is the largest line in this series since 1982 when Virginia was +27 and only lost by 13. While Virginia may only be 1-5, they've been much more competitive than their record indicates and NC is in a flat spot off a huge win so we have a decent lean with the dog getting nearly 4 td's.

Boston College by 1 over GEORGIA TECH - Two 3-3 teams, fresh off a bye, that are desperate for a bowl meet in this ACC tilt. GT is 3-0 ATS in this series, winning LTH 41-30 (+1) in '21 and also won 48-27 (-3) in '20. The Eagles are +25 ypg and coming off two straight wins, beating Virginia and Army by the same exact score (27-24). In fact, five of BC's six games have been decided by 3 points or less! GT has alternated losses with wins each game this year. Their win over Miami was fluky to say the last and prior to their final possession (which should have never happened) the Jackets were getting outgained 446-176. BC is 20-11-1 as an Away Dog since '14 while GTEch is 1-8-1 as a home favorite since '19. We expect a close game so we will take the points.

CINCINNATI by 6 over Baylor - First meeting. Cincy has dropped 4 straight (0-3-1 ATS) and LW were held to 214 yds in a 30-10 loss vs ISU while BU is off a bye. Cincy's offense is led by their run game (203, 4.7) and RB Kiner (434, 5.0) and QB Jones (352, 4.2) and here face a Baylor run D allowing 199 rush ypg (5.4) against Big 12 foes. On the flip side Baylor's rush offense is only avg'g 122 ypg (3.4) and the OLine has allowed 15 sks the L/3 games & here face a Cincy DLine allowing just 104 rush ypg (3.3). Baylor hasn't show many flashes this season outside of their comeback at UCF and despite being 2-4 on the season, Cincy is +59 ypg vs FBS foes and Baylor is -28 ypg vs FBS foes and we'll take the Bearcats by under a td.

CONNECTICUT by 3 over Usf - USF has won 8 straight vs UConn but teams haven't met since 2019. The Bulls have lost 2 straight and are off a 56-14 (-2) home loss to FAU in which they were outgained 587-388 and they have allowed over 200 rush yds in 3 straight gms. Offensively, USF has been plagued by a leaky OLine as they allowed 6 sacks last week and have now allowed 32 on the season. UConn is off a bye and won 38-31 (+10) at Rice their last time out, despite being outgained 474-319 but the Huskies forced 2 TOs and returned a fumble for a td. QB Ta'Quan Roberson has thrown for 970 (60%) with a 7-2 ratio. UConn had an extra week to prepare and USF has to make a long road trip, so we'll take the home team by a fg.

Michigan by 31 over MICHIGAN ST - Michigan St has owned the series the last 15 yrs as they have gone 10-5 SU (13-2 ATS) and have covered 6 of 7 at home and 3 straight overall, plus pulled outright upsets in '20 & '21. The Spartans came off their bye and led Rutgers 17-6 at the half with a 180-158 yd edge and led 24-6 entering the 4Q, but allowed 21 unanswered points and were held to just 20 yds in the 4th and fell 27-24 (+4). RFR Katin Houser made his 1st career start and did not throw an int, but only threw for 133 yds and the Spartans lost 3 fumbles. The MSU defense held Rutgers to 295 yds and has held their last 2 foes under 300 yds. Michigan (6-0, 3-3-1 ATS) beat Indiana 52-7 (-33) but only led 21-7 at HT with a 187-166 yd edge. The Michigan defense pitched 2H shutout and held the Hoosiers to 66 yds in the second half and 232 overall and have held 6 of 7 foes under 260 total yds. Michigan is on a 3-0 ATS run, has won all 4 of their B10 games by at least 24 pts and has no reason to let up in this one and we like the Wolverines by 4 tds over an MSU squad still looking for an identity on offense.

WEST VIRGINIA by 1 over Oklahoma St - From 2015-21 Okla St was 7-0 SU/ATS vs WVU, but LY WVU went to Stillwater in the season finale and won 24-19 despite being -31 yds and -5 FD's. WVU is off a crushing loss at Houston where they all'd UH to complete a last sec hail mary for the 41-39 win after coming back from 35-24 late 4Q. OSU went up 14-0 on KU, LW, but trailed 32-24 3Q before ending the gm on a 15-0 run and pulled another home upset 39-32 (4★ LP winner and Underdog POW winner in PS!) where RB Gordon ran for 168 and had 116 rec yds & QB Bowman threw for a ssn-high 336 yds. WVU has ran for 192 ypg (4.3) but Okla St just held a good Kansas rush attack to 90 rush yds (3.1). WVU has covered 4 of their L/5 gms, but are off a tough loss while Okla St is on a 13-6 ATS run as a Big 12 dog and we'll side with the Cowboys to keep it close. The last 4 meetings have also gone Under the Total so we may look at this game for our Totals GOM.

Rutgers by 3 over INDIANA - Indiana owns a 5-4 series lead, but Rutgers has won and covered the last 2, including a 38-3 (-7) win LTH in '21 but the Scarlet Knights have not won a B10 road game since then (0-7 SU). Rutgers (5-2, 5-1-1 ATS) is off a 27-24 (-4) win over Mich St that saw them rally from a 24-6 4Q deficit as the Scarlet Knights scored 3 tds within a 5:00 span to grab the lead. Rutgers was held under 300 yds (295) for the 3rd time in their last 4 games, but are now allowing just 277 ypg this season. Indiana has lost 3 of 4 after their 52-7 (+33) loss at Michigan as the Hoosiers were held scoreless in the 2H after trailing just 21-7 at the half. Indiana played their 1st game under a new OC, but only mustered 232 total yds and are now averaging just 269 ypg vs FBS foes and they have allowed 10 sacks in the last 3 games. Rutgers is just 8-33 SU on the B10 road since joining the conference and has only been a conf AF twice in B10 play, so while we think they escape with a close win they can't be trusted to cover anything over a fg.

EAST CAROLINA by 3 over Charlotte - 1st mtg despite teams being only 250 miles apart. ECU has struggled to a 1-5 (2-4 ATS) start and are of a 31-10 (+11) Thurs night home loss to SMU. The Pirates got down 14-0 in the 1Q and rallied to pull to 14-10 at HT. ECU seemed to settle on Alex Flinn as their starting QB, but he was pulled after 2 series and Mason Garcia came on the lead the 2 scoring drives. The Pirates went back to Flinn in the 4th, but he threw a pick-6 that put the game out of reach. CLT (1-5, 3-3 ATS) is off a 14-0 (-9) home loss to Navy despite holding Navy's option attack to 173 rush yds (4.3). The game was tied 0-0 at HT as the 49ers held Navy to just 57 1H yards. The CLT offense was held to just 265 total yds and are now averaging just 295 ypg and 14 ppg vs FBS foes. CLT is 3-0 ATS on the road TY and ECU 0-2 SU/ATS at home vs FBS foes, so we'll side with the 49ers getting around a td against a Pirates' squad with major questions at QB.

Utah by 1 over FLORIDA ATLANTIC - 1st mtg since '20. FAU is off a 56-14 (+2) win at USF in which the Owls scored on their 1st possession and never trailed. USF pulled to 21-14 at the half, but the Owls scored tds on their 1st 4 possessions of the 2H and held USF to just 72 yds in the 2H and have held their last 2 opponents to 17 pts or less. UTSA has won 2 straight with QB Harris back under center and is off a 41-20 (-9) home win over UAB. The Roadrunners were actually outgained 364-360 but forced 3 TO's including a strip sack that led to their 2nd td that put them up 14-0 and the Blazers never got closer than 11 pts. After allowing 499 ypg the previous 3 gms, the UTSA D held UAB 74 yds below their season avg. FAU has already played 3 games decided by 7 or less and we think this will be another close one and like the Owls to cover at home vs a UTSA squad that is 1-2 ATS on the road.

Air Force by 10 over NAVY - Air Force has won and covered 5 of the L/7 mtgs against Navy. AF's run defense has done well defending Navy's option of late as they are allowing just 80 rush ypg (2.3) in the L/3 mtgs. AF edged out Wyo last week 34-27 where they ran for 356 yds (6.7) but lost QB Larrier to a leg inj & was replaced by Jensen Jones. Navy picked up their 2nd straight win LW, beating Charlotte 14-0 but only put up 265 yds. This season AF has another strong run D as they are allowing just 77 ypg (2.8) and overall the Falcons D is holding teams to 99 ypg under their avg (#10 FBS). Navy's run D this season is allowing 149 (4.1) but here face the #1 rush offense in the FBS as AF is running for 334 ypg (5.6) and 4 players have at least 300 rush yds. In their L/5 wins vs Navy, AF has won 4 by DD's and this is a strong Falcons team we see winning by DD's.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 20 over ULM - GS is 5-1 SU vs ULM as SBC foes, but are just 2-4 ATS but this is the first time ULM will face GS since their switch in offenses. GS is off a 41-13 loss at JMU where they were just -16 yds but were -3 TO's. ULM held TXST offense to 21 pts LW & led 20-9 but still gave up 452 yds and lost. GS's pass attack is putting 332 ypg and QB Brin is hitting 68% and has a 12-9 ratio but 5 int's came in 1 game. That pass attack will pose a problem for ULM as they have the #123 pass D and are allowing 336 pass ypg (67%) the last 4 gms & overall ULM's D is giving up 534 ypg/41 ppg the L/4 gms. ULM is 1-8 SU/4-5 ATS in SBC road gms under Bowden (avg loss by 17 pts) and we think this is a mismatch and like GS by nearly 3 tds.

Appalachian St by 4 over OLD DOMINION - As FBS foes App St is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS against ODU. They met last season and App St (-16) led 24-0 HT but ODU came back to get the cover as the final was App St 27-14. App hasn't played in 11 days where they fell to SBC East rival CC 27-24 on a last-sec FG and are now just 3-3 SU/2-3-1 ATS on the season. ODU is off a bye & last faced SMISS where they won 17-13 & held SMISS to 276 yds. These tms have faced nearly the same sked strength (App #101, ODU #109) and App is +58 ypg/+4 ppg TY while ODU is just -21 ypg/-3 ppg. However App St is on a 3-9-1 ATS run as an away favorite in SBC play while ODU has covered 4 straight gms as an underdog & we see ODU keeping this gm within the line.

Central Michigan by 10 over BALL ST - Visitor has won 6 straight & covered 7 straight in series. LTH CM (-2) led just 28-17 at HT but pulled a 2H shut out to win 37-17. LW CM despite losing their top tackler LB Moretti, (on crutches early 3Q), they had their best performance holding Akron to 10 pt & 193 yds. Ball St is just 1-6 SU and is just 1-4-1 ATS vs FBS foes all as a dog. Their only cover was LW as a 17' pt HD vs Toledo in a swirling rain. They tied the game a 6-6 w/4:56 left but allowed a GW td w/1:31 left. They were outgained 376-205 but forced 2 short FG, 2 SOD & recovered a fumble at BS8. CM is 4-3 SU & 2-1 in MAC play will be focused here with games vs NIU, UT & Miami still on deck. Ball St is being outscored by 24 ppg vs FBS foes losing all by 7+ as they have our #132 OFF. CM has opened as only around a FG favorite and seem the play here.

BOWLING GREEN by 7 over Akron - Both teams are playing their 8th straight week. While Falcons are 11-3 SU & 10-4 ATS vs the Zips the Visitor is 5-2 SU & 4-3 ATS. LY BG (-9) led 17-7 2Q but alternated scored the rest of the game and only won 31-28 with just a 422-408 yd edge. BG is off a 24-14 upset of Buffalo as a 3' pt AD finishing with a 295-238 yd edge. Akron was upset by Buffalo 3 weeks ago losing 13-10 in OT as a 3 pt HF only being outgained 254-253. Akron is just 1-6 SU but covered LW at CM, only losing 17-10 as a 10 pt AD. Falcons have the edge on both OFF (#120-#131)

& DEF (#72-#94) but are just 1-2 SU & ATS in MAC play. Akron is 3-1 ATS as a road dog and with BG opening as over a td favorite we will look for the Zips to keep it under that.

Buffalo by 10 over KENT ST - Home team has won & covered 4 of the last 5 but LY despite trailing 24-10 into 4Q, Kent St (+4) forced OT & won it there 30-27. Flashes are just 1-6 SU & 2-5 ATS including a 28-14 loss to EM LW as an 8 pt HD. They lost despite a 343-218 yd edge but desperate for a win, opened with an Onside kick that EM returned for a td & were SOD twice including at EM 5. After opening 0-4, Buffalo looked to have gotten on track with 2 straight wins but LW lost 24-14 to BG as a 3' pt HF. Bulls have only slight edges on both offense (#121-#129) & defense (#107-#112) and are all g just 303 ypg/16 ppg in MAC play and think they get the win here by DD's.

MIAMI, OH by 2 over Toledo - Surprisingly this is just their 12th meeting with Miami leading 6-4-1 SU & 6-5 ATS. Last met in 2011 when Rockets were a 16' pt HF & led 28-0 2Q winning 49-28. Both have a win over WM. UT won 49-31 with a 497-393 yd edge but did not cover as a 21' pt HF. LW Miami beat WM 34-21 with a 315-303 yd edge covering as an 5' pt AF. LW in a swirling rain UT as a 17' pt AF struggled to get past Ball St 13-6 scoring the GW td with 1:31 left. Both teams come in 6-1 SU & 3-0 in MAC play with both at the top of their conf division. However Toledo is on a 0-5 ATS run while Miami has covered 6 straight. UT has the offensive edge (#56-#105) but MU has the defensive edge (#50-#73). With two even teams we will take the Home Dog.

OHIO by 21 over Western Michigan - Visitor has won & covered last 4 regular ssn mtgs & WM is 7-3 SU & 6-4 ATS vs Ohio since 2000. LTH WM (E) led 10-0 a HT but game went to OT, where WM pulled out the 37-34 win. LY Ohio (E) never trailed but up just 20-14 at HT but shut down WM in 2H pulling away for a 33-14 win. WMich is just 2-5 SU but 4-3 ATS. LW WM (+8) lost 34-21 at home to MAC East leader Miami but were only outgained 315-303. LW Ohio was riding a 5 game winning streak (4 straight covers) but lost 23-13 at NIU as a 5' pt AF. They were only outgained 302-254 but after throwing just 2 int in his first 5 gms Ohio QB Rourke threw 3 in the 2H vs NIU. Ohio is 10-1 SU & ATS in regular ssn MAC games and should bounce back here. We won our Sept Totals GOM on Ohio/lowa SU UNDER 42' (10-7 final) could we go back to the Bobcats again for our Oct Totals GOM?

Wisconsin by 7 ILLINOIS - UW is 11-2 SU/8-5 ATS in this series, but IL pulled the 34-10 (+6) upset in Madison LY that was the final game for former HC Paul Chryst. The Illini are off a 27-24 (+13) upset win at MD ILW as they got a GW 43 fg as time expired. IL was actually outgained 380-337 but did just enough to end their 0-6 ATS run to start the year. After rushing for 21 yds the previous week, the Illini posted 131 rush yds (3.4) but did allow 5 sacks. UW lost 15-6 (-9) at home to Iowa and QB Mordecai went out with a hand injury in the 1Q and will miss this one. RFR Braedyn Locke stepped in and hit 16-31 for 130 and an int. UW has a showdown with Ohio St on deck and IL is on a bye next week, but this is a must win for the Badgers if they want any shot at the B10 West title so we'll take the Badgers despite the injury concerns at QB.

IOWA by 10 over Minnesota - Iowa has won 8 straight (6-1-1 ATS) vs Min and hasn't lost at home to the Gophers since '99 (10-0 SU/7-2-1 ATS). The L/2 mtgs in the series have been decided by 5 pts or less. Min is off a bye and enters this one at 3-3 (1-5 ATS) and most recently lost 52-10 (+19) at home to Mich and the Gophers were held to 169 yds, incl just 52 passing! Min is now avg'g just 139 pass ypg and has yet to top 200 pass yds TY. After allowing 115 rush ypg the F/4 wks, the Gophers have allowed 184 ypg the L2W. Iowa is off a 15-6 win at Wis which puts Iowa in control of their own destiny in the B10 West. Iowa is averaging just 15 ppg and 207 ypg in conf play and have been outgained in every B10 game, but are holding foes to 77 ypg below their season avg. Min did have an extra week to prepare, but that isn't enough time to fix their passing game especially going on the road vs an Iowa D that is #6 in our Pass D ratings, so we like Iowa to continue their series dominance with a double-digit win.

NEW MEXICO by 7 over Hawaii - As MW foes NMex is 3-2 SU/ATS but have dropped the L/2 gms SU and their last meeting came back in 2020. Despite leading 17-14 HT LW NMex lost 52-24 vs SJSU (-140 yds) while UH had the yds edge (480-378) vs SDSt but lost 41-34 as UH was -3 TO's and that led to 21 pts for SDSt. UH is a one-dimensional offense, as their run game is avg'g just 58 ypg (2.4) while their pass attack is avg'g 300 ypg but the UH OL has all'd 26 sks however the NMEx pass D ranks #130 and are 1 of just 2 tms to not have an int this ssn. NMex's offense has shown improvement, avg'g 391 ypg/28 ppg and their run game is avg'g 170 (5.0) for the season and UH's run D is giving up 214 (5.7) rush ypg the L/4 gms. If NMex is going to get to a bowl game they need a win here, and are only laying around a FG at home and we see the Lobos winning by a td.

SAN DIEGO ST by 17 over Nevada - LY's 23-7 win by SDSt (-7) over Nev was the Aztecs first cover over the Wolf Pack since 2017. SDSt is off a 41-34 win vs Hawaii where they were 102 yds but turned 3 UH TO's into 21 pts, but did allow 427 pass yds. SDSt had a brutal early schedule facing UCLA, Oreg St, Boise & AF but now have taken a step down in competition as they faced Hawaii LW and now Nev and SDSt has the #6 ST & Nev is #107. SDSt QB Mayden is hitting 63% with a 6-6 ratio, but faces the #133 pass D that is allowing 315 ypg (77%). While SDSt's D is allowing foes to gain 56 ypg above their avg (#122 FBS) however Nev's offense is putting up just 323 ypg/17 ppg and are -189 ypg/-22 ppg. The Aztecs are better than their 3-4 record & we like them at home by over 2 tds.

Ucla by 24 over STANFORD - The Cardinal return home on extra rest following a Friday night trip to Boulder where they overcame a 29-0 HT deficit in a 2OT win over the Buffs (QB Daniels 435 ttl yds & 4 TD). The Bruins meanwhile are on their road for a 2nd straight week after a rough outing in Corvallis where we picked up a 3★ Newsletter Winner along with a Top Play LP 4★ on the Beavers (UCLA QB Moore 3rd straight gm throwing a pick-6). After winning 11 straight in this series (10-1 ATS) with a 17 pt MOV, the Cardinal have lost 3 of the L/4 against UCLA including a 38-13 (+16) defeat LY inside of the Rose Bowl where the Bruins finished with a 523-270 yd edge. BYU (+) over Texas Tech - Only prior meeting came in 1940! TT is off a 38-21 loss to KSt where QB Morton was replaced by true frosh Jake Strong, but as of now Morton is still the starter. BYU was beat up 44-11 against TCU where they were outgained by 341 yds. BYU has struggled to get their run game going TY, avg'g just 68 ypg (2.4) and TT has gotten good production from their run D, all'g just 147 (3.9) but did allow KSt to run for 272 (5.8) LW. TT's pass D does sit at #63 and BYU QB Slovis has a 10-3 ratio. BYU's run D has struggled vs Big 12 foes (232, 5.5) and TT's run game has been solid (179, 4.9) led by RB Brooks (786, 6.0, 4 100 yd gms TY). However BYU is 19-3 SU at home since '20 and are the dog here. Provo is a tough place to place and TT could be starting a true frosh QB making his first career road start in a hostile stadium. We'll call for the Cougars to win outright!

USC by 10 over Utah - Rematch of LY's P12 Title game where the Utes (+2') outscored the Trojans 30-7 in the 2H of their eventual 23 pt victory (Utah QB Rising 22-34-310-3-0). Their earlier meeting in SLC also saw Utah (+3') pull off a 43-42 victory with a GW 2 pt conv with :48 remaining (QB's Williams & Rising combined for 913 ttl yds & 10 TD's!). The Utes head to LA following a 20 pt home win over Cal where their defense continued to dominate (avg just 217 ypg all'd through 6 gms). The Trojans meanwhile suffered their 1st loss on the year LW in South Bend thanks in part to a 5-0 TO deficit (outgained ND 302-251). USC has covered 7 of their L/11 as home chalk dating back to LY and are only laying under a td here. Utah isn't nearly as good on the road and USC is out for legit revenge so we have the Trojans by double-digits.

WASHINGTON by 21 over Arizona St - Following their huge win LW against the Ducks where QB Penix threw for 302 yds with a 4-1 ratio (UW outgained 541-415), the Huskies are right back at home TW to take on a Sun Devils squad that's well-rested after their bye week. ASU has actually dominated this series with victories in 13 of the past 15 (14-1 ATS) including a 45-38 (+13') upset LY in the desert (UW 32-23 FD & 458-397 yd edges). With the Sun Devils also going an outstanding 11-4 ATS as an AD the past 6 years, we'll support the recent series history and call for them to stay inside of the elevated line.

OREGON by 13 over Washington St - The Ducks suffered their 1st blemish of the ssn LW in Seattle thanks in part to a handful of questionable coaching decisions throughout (missed game-tying 43 yd FG w/:00 left, UO 31-24 FD & 541-415 yd edges). They now play host to a Cougars squad that's heading in the wrong direction the L/2 wks including a 44-6 (-7') home loss LW to Arizona where they were forced into 3 TO's and 3 SOD's (WSU outgained 516-234). While the recent series has been split at 4 apiece, WSU has done well staying within the spread by going 6-1-1 ATS including LY where they dropped a narrow 44-41 defeat in the Palouse (+6') with the Ducks storming back in the 4Q with 29 pts including a game-sealing 27-yd pick-6 with 1:01 remaining (UO 624-428 yd edge). With the Cougs putting up an impressive 14-6-1 ATS mark in recent P12 gms along with LW's embarrassment, they should keep this much closer than expected with Oregon having another key road trip to SLC on deck.

SAN JOSE ST by 3 over Utah St - USU has won and covered their last 7 mts against SJSt & the L/5 gms have gone 'OVER' the total with an avg of 67 pts. USU is off a 37-32 loss vs Fresno last Fri where they had the yds edge (568-461) but were -2 TO's. SJSt picked up a 52-24 win at NMex LW where they were down 17-14 HT but outgained the Lobos 375-130 in 2H. SJSt has played the tougher sked (#47 vs #88) and their D has all'd 396 ypg but here face a USU offense that has put up 500+ yds in 3 of their L/4 gms & their pass attack is avg'g 367 ypg the L/4 gms and SJSt's pass D ranks #104 (63%, 11-4 ratio). However USU's pass D ranks #81 and SJSt has exp'd QB Cordeiro under center. While we see SJSt getting the win, the series history has us leaning with the visitors to get the cover.

OKLAHOMA by 24 over Ucf - First meeting. Both teams are off a bye, but are headed in opposite directions as OU is 6-0 SU/5-0-1 ATS and last upset Texas, while UCF has dropped their first 3 Big 12 gms both SU/ATS. In fact UCF is -75 ypg/-14 ppg in conf play and are allowing 491 ypg/44 ppg. That could be an issue as OU's offense is putting up 175 ypg more than their foes allow (#3 FBS) and are led by QB Gabriel (1878, 72%, 16-2). OU's run game could also have a big day against a UCF run D giving up 278 ypg (6.2) in Big 12 play. OU's defense has also been improved TY and are holding foes to 59 ypg under their avg. UCF is also just 1-4 ATS as an away dog under Malzahn and in Norman we think UCF will be overmatched & have OU by 3+ td's!

Texas by 28 over HOUSTON - 26th meeting, but have not met since 2002 where Texas won 41-11 in Austin. Texas is off a bye week after losing 34-30 against rival OU where they were +41 yds but were -3 TO's. Houston is off their first Big 12 win last Thur where they won on the final play of the game with a hail mary. Texas QB Ewers is hitting 70% (11-3) this season & UH just all'd WVU to throw for a season-high 391 yds. UH also has struggled to stop the run vs Big 12 foes (215, 4.9) and Texas RB Brooks has 725 rush (6.8) on the season. On the flip side Texas has the #5 pass D and UH QB Smith won't have the same success throwing the ball. Texas overall has a big edge on defense (#13 vs #108). Off a bye and re-focused, we see Texas winning by 4 td's.

KANSAS ST by 12 over Tcu - LY's 38-28 win by TCU in the reg ssn snapped KSt's 4 gm SU/ATS in the series & KSt did defeat TCU in the B12 title gm LY. KSt is off a 38-21 win at TT last week where QB Howard was replaced by true frosh QB Avery Johnson & he ran for 5 td's. TCU also got an impressive performance from a true frosh QB in Josh Hoover, who threw for 439 yds (4-2 ratio) in a 44-11 win vs BYU where we picked up a 3★ PS and 3★ LP winner on TCU. While we were impressed by TCU LW, KSt has faced the tougher sked (#29 vs #73) and are on a 7-1 ATS run as a Big 12 HF, and QB Hoover will be making his 1st road start in front of a great crowd. We'll back the Wildcats here by DD's.

ALABAMA by 13 over Tennessee - Bama is out for revenge after losing to Tenn last year for the first time in 16 years which sent Vols' fans dumping the goal posts in the river. Last week Josh Heupel won his first game as a HC when his offense was held under 30 points, beating A&M 20-13 (-3). The Vols ran for 232 yds on the #1 rush D in the SEC but QB Milton only threw for 100 yards and the difference was a PR td. Bama led Ark 24-6 and had force 5 consecutive 3 & out's but allowed two 2H td's and held on 24-21 (-19'). Bama finished w/a 415-250 yd edge. Bama has allowed 31 sacks (19%) and they are rushing for a Saban era worst 3.8 ypg. Tenn's offense hasn't traveled well, losing their last 3 true road games (not counting Vandy for obvious reasons). Tenn is 4-5 SU/ATS on the road and Bama should be as fired up as it gets for this game. The Oline is a concern considering Tenn has 24 sacks this year but they only had 1 at Florida. Bama hasn't been a single-digit home favorite since they beat Georgia 41-24 (-5) in '20. We think Joe Milton will struggle against the Bama D on the road so we've got the Tide by under 2 td's. Saban is also 16-1 SU/11-6 ATS when out for revenge.

Memphis by 8 over UAB - 1st meeting since '12. Memphis is just 2-10 SU (3-9 ATS) in AAC road games under HC Silverfield, although they did go 3-1 LY. The Tigers are off a 31-21 (+5) home loss to Tulane but they actually led 21-10 early 3Q but down 3 a dropped pass was int'd and Tulane scored then Memphis was SOD in UAB territory on their final drive. UAB fell 41-20 (-9) at UTSA despite outgaining the Roadrunners 364-360. QB Zeno was sacked 6 times and threw 2 ints. The Blazers defense allowed 183 rush yds (4.8) and are now allowing 202 rush ypg (5.5) on the year.

Memphis has played a tough schedule including a 7 point loss to Missouri. We like the Tigers defensive edge to be the difference and call for Memphis by over a td.

AUBURN by 1 over Ole Miss - Hugh Freeze meets his former team as an SEC coach for the first time. He did face Ole Miss once as HC at Liberty, losing 27-14 in '21. Auburn is 10-4 ATS in this series with 3 straight covers. Auburn has lost 3 straight and were no match for LSU's high powered offense last week, outgained 563-293 in a 30 pt loss. Auburn did end their streak of being held under 100 pass yards by 6 straight P5 foes, throwing for 154 yds vs LSU. Ole Miss is fresh off a bye and three weeks ago they beat that same LSU team 55-49. The Rebels avg 489 ypg and are +101 ypg while Aub avg 347 ypg and are -16 ypg. However Auburn is allowing 363 ypg and holding foes 52 ypg below their avg while Ole Miss is allowing 388 ypg and 6 ypg more than their foes avg. Auburn has struggled on the road but nearly upset Georgia at home and we think they can pull the upset here.

LOUISIANA by 7 over Georgia St - The Cajuns are 6-0 SU against GSst as SBC foes but have yet to cover vs GS (0-4-2 ATS). LA is off a bye week and sit at 4-2 SU, while GSst took down Marshall 41-24 despite being just +17 yds as they blk'd a punt & ret'd it for a td. While the Cajuns strength on offense is their run game (225, 6.1) they are facing a GSst pass D that is allowing 301 ypg (66%) and QB Chriss hit 76% last week & threw for 205 yds and 3 td's. GSst does run the ball well (185, 4.7) but the Cajuns are allowing 152 rush ypg, but just 3.6 ypc. LA also has a massive ST's edge (#8 vs #112) in this game and at home off a bye laying less than a FG, we'll take the Cajuns by a td.

NEBRASKA by 16 over Northwestern - NW is 4-6 (7-4 ATS) in the series, but pulled the 31-28 (+11') outright upset LY in Ireland which turned out to be NW's only win. Neb did dominate NW LTH here in '21 in a 56-7 (-11') win as they outgained NW 657-293. Both teams are coming off a bye and both won last time out, although NW's win came over FCS Howard while Nebraska won at Illinois. The Huskers held Illinois to 21 rush yds in their 20-7 (+3') win and are now allowing just 76 (2.7) rush ypg. QB Haarberg has thrown for 631 (52%) with a 4-2 ratio and is also the leading rusher (352, 5.1) as the Huskers avg 201 (5.0) rush ypg. NWest starting QB Ben Bryant missed LW's 23-20 (-24') and backup Brendan Sullivan led to Wildcats to victory, despite throwing for just 131 yds and it wouldn't be surprising to see both play here. The Wildcats are 0-2 SU/ATS on the road TY and have lost by 17 & 24 pts and we expect a stifling Nebraska defense to dominate the action and the Husker's offense to just enough to get a cover.

MISSOURI by 3 over South Carolina - Mizzou has won & covered the last 4 meetings and they've held SC under 300 yds in each of those. The Tigers are 6-1 SU this year after beating Kentucky 38-21 last week. They trailed 14-0 1Q, allowing 65 & 63 yd td drives but their offense was sparked after a 39 yd td pass on a fake punt. SC led Florida 37-27 4Q but allowed the Gators to drive 75 yd/14 plays and 75 yd/9 plays for td's with 4:40 and :47 left. QB Rattler threw for 313 yards and now has an 11-4 ratio. SC's Oline has been much improved. They allowed just 2 sacks last week and avg'd 4.6 ypc. Mizzou has the edge on D, holding foes 50 ypg below their avg (#31) while SC is allowing 27 ypg more than their foes avg (#101). However, the Gamecocks do have 3 losses to Top 15 teams (NC, UGA, Tenn) and have played our #1 schedule strength! Mizzou is just 2-8 as a HF and at 2-4 SC is desperate for a win so we are leaning with the dog here. Missouri has gone Over their Total in 5 straight games and SC has gone Over in 3 straight so obviously this game will be in the mix for our Totals GOM!

TULANE by 18 over North Texas - The only previous meeting was back in 2013. UNT got their 1st AAC win last week in a 45-14 (-6) home win over Temple. The Mean Green amassed 527 yds of total offense with 220 (5.9) coming on the ground. They have now rushed for over 200 yds in 5 straight gms, but have allowed 12 sacks the last 2 weeks. The are still having issues stopping the run as they allowed 242 (4.8) to Temple and are now allowing 274 rush ypg vs FBS foes. Tulane is off a 31-21 (-5) win at Memphis in which they trailed 21-10 in the 3Q, but scored 21 unanswered to come away with the win. The Green Wave held Memphis to 45 rush yds (2.4) and has now held 5 of their 6 opponents under 100 rush yds while allowing 78 (2.6) rush ypg. QB Pratt has thrown for 927 (71%) with a 9-1 ratio. This line opened around 3 tds and Tulane is already 0-2 ATS as a 20 pt plus favorite this year and is also just 1-3 ATS at home so we like North Texas to cover in this one.

LSU by 28 over Army - Only prior meeting was in 1931. LSU faces a Service Academy time since that game although Brian Kelly did face Service Academies every year during his time at Notre Dame. Two very contrasting offenses here. LSU avg 551 ypg and is #2 in the FBS, putting up 174 ypg more than their foes allow. Army isn't as run heavy as year's past but still only avg 340 ypg and 25 ppg. They are being held 76 ypg under what their foes allow on avg. LSU has a bye on deck before playing Bama. We doubt HC Kelly is going to put his players at great risk and will look to get out unscathed and healthy. Army did keep it close against Syracuse and BC this year. We cashed our 4★ Top Totals play on Army/Troy Under 42 in the Black Knights 19-0 loss. LSU has gone Over the Total in all 7 games this year which puts them in the mix for our Totals GOM!

New Mexico St at LOUISIANA TECH - NMSt is 0-5 in Ruston with their avg loss by 24.2 ppg but they haven't played here since '11. The Aggies have a game against UTEP prior to this one. They are 4-3 SU/3-2-1 ATS at presstime, with 2 of their losses coming on the road and were outgained in all 3 road games. LT is 3-5 SU/ATS at presstime but does come off a bye. LT is 5-4 SU/6-3 ATS at home under Cumbie. LT has the edge on D, holding foes to 381 ypg while NMSt has the edge on offense avg 440 ypg. Call 1-800-654-3448 and purchase our Tuesday Night Marquee for just \$12.

Liberty at WKU - A win here likely locks up a spot in the CUSA Title game for whoever wins. Liberty is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS at presstime with a game vs Middle Tenn yet to be decided. The Flames are +163 ypg but have our #105 sked. WKU is 4-2 SU/ATS with a game vs Jax St yet to be decided. They are -70 ypg but part of that was because they were thrashed by Ohio St. WKU has 3 home wins by 22 ppg but only +20 ypg. This game features the two best CUSA QB's in Austin Reed (61%, 14-3) and Kaidon Salter (58%, 14-2, 337 rush). Liberty has the edge on defense (#74 vs #122). WKU has covered 8 of their last 12 as home dogs.

4★ Green Bay over DENVER - Rematch of Super Bowl XXXII (1997) where the Broncos pulled off a monumental upset for their very 1st Lombardi Title. The Packers have had their way in this series over recent years however with victories in 4 of the L/5 ('03-'19) including a 27-16 (-7) win inside of Lambeau. The Broncos haven't had much success in recent home contests (2-6-1 ATS run) that includes an 0-3 SU/ATS mark so far in '23 (all 3 listed as a favorite). They actually haven't had any type of success TY overall as last Thur's 19-8 defeat in Arrowhead was their 6th straight ATS loss to begin the year (QB Wilson 13-22-95-1-2, KC 389-197 yd edge). 3★ Pittsburgh over LA RAMS - Rematch of Super Bowl XIV (1979) that saw the Steelers pick up their 4th "Big Game" victory in a 6-year span. PIT heads West following their week off (4-1 ATS after a bye) while the Rams got back on track LW against DIV rival ARZ with WR Kupp pulling in 148 yds and a TD in his 2nd game back from injury. The Steelers have come out victorious in each of the past 4 matchups (SU & ATS, 14 pt avg MOV) including a 17-12 (+4) home upset of the Rams in '19. With PIT also on a solid 7-2 ATS run overall, we'll call for them to get the outright upset here (plenty of Steelers fans expected to make the trip to LA) as the Rams have failed to cover 4 of their L/6 as home chalk while also going 5-11-2 ATS in meetings with the AFC. **FORECAST: Pittsburgh by 6**

2★ Detroit over BALTIMORE - The Ravens are at home following a 3-wk road trip that included an 8 pt win over the Titans LW in London where they finished with a 360-233 yd edge. The Lions meanwhile continued their impressive run to start the ssn with a 14 pt road win against the Bucs where they allowed just a pair of FG's, 13 FD's and 251 yds. The Lions have dropped each of the past 4 meetings (1-3 ATS) with the Ravens including a 19-17 (+7) home defeat in '21 where BAL K Justin Tucker hit a GW 66-yd FG as time expired! DET is however 10-3 ATS when listed as the dog and 14-2 ATS in recent contests overall. With BAL failing to cover 8 of their L/10 as home chalk, we're leaning with the visitor in this one. **FORECAST: Detroit by 6**

OTHER PLAYS

Jacksonville at NEW ORLEANS - Thursday - The Saints are at home for the only time in a 4-wk span following a shutout win in NE and a 7 pt loss LW in HOU where they had 24-19 FD and 430-297 yd edges (trip to IND on deck). The Jags meanwhile played their lone "true" HG in a 5-wk span LW against the Colts with their defense forcing 4 TO's in a 17 pt victory (IND 354-233 yd edge). The Saints have dominated the past 4 matchups in this series (4-0 ATS, 12 pt avg MOV) including a 13-6 (+3) win at JAX in '19 where they had 18-11 FD and 326-226 yard edges. While the Jags have gone just 8-32 ATS against the NFC, the Saints have failed to cover each of their past 4 contests in the Superdome overall. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

TAMPA BAY by 1 over Atlanta - The Bucs had their share of struggles in their return from bye a week ago against the Lions with just 2 FG's in a 20-6 home defeat. They're now back at home for a 2nd straight week to take on a Falcons squad that dropped a 24-16 home contest LW against WAS thanks to 3 int's thrown by QB Ridder (ATL 25-13 FD & 402-193 yd edges). The Falcons ended a 5-game losing skid (2-3 ATS) in LY's ssn finale against the Bucs (rested some starters) with 22-12 FD and 382-222 yard edges in the 30-17 (-4) victory. With ATL covering 5 of their L/7 inside of the NFC South and the Bucs going just 2-5-1 ATS as home chalk, the visitor stays within the line in this one.

Las Vegas by 6 over CHICAGO - After ending their 14-game losing skid 2 wks ago on the road against the Commanders, the Bears were unable to pick up a 2nd straight win LW at home against the Vikings with QB Fields leaving in the 2H with injury (CHI 18-12 FD & 275-220 yd edges, -2 TO's). They're now back inside of Soldier Field where they haven't tasted victory since way back in Wk 2 of LY (10 consec home losses) to take on a Raiders squad that picked up their 2nd straight win LW against the Patriots (LV 348-259 yd edge). In their most recent meeting ('21), the Bears (+5) picked up a surprising 20-9 upset victory despite just 252 yards of offense. While the Bears have gone a solid 9-4-1 ATS against the AFC coming in, the potential absence of Fields here has us calling for the Raiders to continue their winning streak.

Cleveland by 6 over INDIANAPOLIS - The Browns are playing just their 2nd AG of the ssn following a surprising home win against the 49ers where PJ Walker (18-34-192-0-2) became the 36th different starting QB since 1999 with Deshaun Watson out again with injury (CLE 18-15 FD & 334-215 yd edges). The Colts meanwhile return home after a dismal effort by bkp QB Minshew (4 TO's) against the Jags. Following a 3-game losing streak from '12-'17 (1-2 ATS), the Browns (-1) grabbed a 32-23 home victory in '20 with 22-15 FD and 385-308 yard edges. While the Browns are just 4-11 ATS as an AF coming in, their defense has been "Lights Out" nearly all ssn long (CLE has all'd the fewest yds thru 5 gms s/1971!).

Buffalo by 14 over NEW ENGLAND - The struggles continued a week ago for the Patriots as the Raiders held them to just 259 yds in their 4 pt victory in Las Vegas. NE now returns home where they were shutout 2 weeks ago against the Saints (Pats just 8 FD & 156 yds). The Bills struggled throughout in their return from London with a 5 pt home win against an injury-plagued Giants squad who led 6-0 at HT and finished with a 317-297 yd edge (BUF -2 TO's). After going 35-4 SU from the latter part of 2000 to the end of 2019, the Patriots have now lost 6 of the past 7 (2-5 ATS) against the Bills including a 24-10 loss (+3) defeat LY in Foxboro (BUF 22-14 FD & 355-242 yd edges). With the Bills going an impressive 10-5-1 ATS against DIV foes overall and the Pats failing to cover 12 of their L/14 as a dog, the visitor gets a 2 TD edge in this one.

Washington by 6 over NY GIANTS - The Giants continue to be a "Hot Mess" following a 5 pt loss LW in BUF where they were without a slew of players on both sides of the ball. They now welcome a Commanders squad that ended a 3-gm losing skid LW in ATL behind 3 TD passes from QB Howell (ATL 25-13 FD & 402-193 yd edges, -3 TO's). Following

In their most recent meeting in '19, the Dolphins (+10) picked up a surprising 37-31 home upset by overcoming a 28-14 deficit in the 3Q! While MIA is on a 7-1 ATS run, the Eagles are 6-3 ATS in meetings with the AFC while covering 6 of the L/8 as a NDIV HF. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**
