4★ James Madison over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - Tms met as FCS foes from 1985-92 with GS winning 7 of 8 SU. JMU is off a 42-20 win at Ark St (33-11 FD edge) and are 5-0 SU/ATS TY & are now ranked for the 1st time as an FBS tm! GS faced rival GS last wk and fell 41-33 (-70 yds, -3 TO's). The GS pass attack continues to shine, avg'g 322 ypg and have all'd just 2 sks in 284 att! However, they run into a JMU pass D that ranks #29 & is all'g 188 ypg (54%) and JMU also has 18 sks TY (13.2%) incl 6 last wk. Overall JMU's DEF is holding foes to 181 ypg under their ssn avg (#1 FBS!). GS has the #104 pass D (all'g 260 ypg/67% vs FBS foes) and overall are all'g foes to gain 78 ypg above their ssn avg (#122) and the JMU offense is putting up 489 ypg/44 ppg incl 215 rush ypg & GS has all'd 233 rush ypg (5.6) L/4 gms. With JMU not being able to make the SBC title gm or a bowl, they are out to prove a point every week & we like them to continue their winning ways by nearly 3 td's. Our top play in Power Sweep has had a rough start so we are going to take a team on a streak to end our streak.

FORECAST: James Madison by 20

3★ Wisconsin over MICHIGAN ST - 1st mtg since 2019 & WISC has won & covered the L/2 mtgs. The Badgers got back into the win column after 2 straight losses, as interim HC Jim Leonhard took the first step towards claiming the job permanently, with a dominant 42-7 (-10) win at N'Western. The Badgers gashed the Wildcats D for 193 rush yds, including 136 (5.9 ypc) by RB Allen, who now leads the tm with 634 yds on the ssn. The Badgers out'd the Wildcats 350-130 in the 1H as they built a 28-0 HT lead. MSU comes in on a 4 gm SU/ATS losing streak after their 49-20 (+27) home loss to Ohio St. The Spartans were out'd 614-202, incl 429-117 in the 1H. Their much-maligned Def is now all'g 37 ppg & 529 ypg against P5 foes. Mich St has also failed to generate consistent offense, as they are avg just 47 rush ypg in their L/4 & face a Badgers D that has allowed 117 rush (3.6) on the ssn. Despite their 2 earlier losses, the Badgers still have a chance to win the B10 West, so we expect them to keep the positive vibes going and we've had a lot of success going against Sparty (3 LPS winners L/4 wks!).

FORECAST: Wisconsin by 17

3★ MIDDLE TENNESSEE over Wku - LY MT had to play this game with their 3rd string QB, a true frosh, making his first start and he threw 5 int's. The 'Toppers were held to a ssn low 352 yds but were +7 TO's and won 48-21. MT is coming off a 41-14 (+9) loss at UAB where they trailed 38-7 and was outg'd 439-130 in the 1H. WKU fell just short in their bid to get revenge for LY's CUSA Title gm, losing 31-28 at UTSA (+6). QB Reed threw for 373 and 2 td's but the 'Toppers were SOD 3x in the 2H including their final drive at the UTSA34. The last time MT was coming off a brutal beatdown was to JMU in the opener and they bounced back with a 34-19 upset win at Colo St the following week. QB Cunningham has a 25-7 ratio going back to LY. We like Stockstill's bunch, who are 25-10-1 ATS off a SU loss to bounce back with their 3rd outright upset of the ssn.

FORECAST: MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 3

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ New Mexico over NEW MEXICO ST - 112th mtg of the Rio Grande Rivalry. NMSt has covered 5 of the L/6 gms. Both offenses struggle to move the ball as NMex is gaining 132 ypg less than their foes allow (#129) while NMSt is gaining 124 ypg less than their foes allow (#127). NMex has gotten out to a 17-0 lead and 10-0 lead the L/2 gms and did move the ball some by WY (319 yds) but couldn't sustain the success & did just fire their OC after LW's gm while NMSt's best performance was vs a poor Hawaii tm (438 yds/45 pts). The biggest difference here is NMex's strong DEF. If you take out the LSU gm, NMex is all'g just 270 ypg & they held LSU to 291 yds in 1H but were worn down in 2H. Meanwhile NMSt is all'g 33 ypg more than their foes gain (#103 FBS). We also give the coaching edge to NMex as they have veteran DC Rocky Long who takes this rivalry personally. We'll take the stronger defense here to shut down NMSt and win by 2 td's.

FORECAST: New Mexico by 14

2★ Penn St (+) over MICHIGAN - Tms have split the L/6 in series & the road team has won the last 2, incl a 27-17 (+1) win by the Nittany Lions LTH in 2020. Penn St comes in at 5-0 (3-2 ATS) & is off a bye. Their Def is all'g just 15 ppg on the ssn, incl just 11 ppg the L/4. Offensively, the Nittany Lions feature a 1-2 punch at RB, with Singelton (7.3) & Allen (5.3) both avg over 5 ypc. MICH also comes in undefeated, on the strength of a 31-10 (-22) road win at IND where the MICH Def pitched a shutout in the 2H & limited IND to just 29 2H yds, incl -12 yds in the 4Q. The MICH D is allowing just 82 rush ypg (2.6) & has turned up the pressure in B10 play with 14 sks the last 3 wks. RB Corum has been the Wolverines catalyst with 735 (6.2) but PSU is allowing just 81 rush ypg (3.0). This is an important game for B10 East positioning & although we like MICH to get the win, they have failed to cover the L/2 gm gms, so we expect a rested PSU team, who is already 2-0 ATS on the road, to keep this one within a td.

FORECAST: MICHIGAN by 3

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 12TH

Louisiana at MARSHALL - Only prior mtg was in last season's New Orleans Bowl where LA won 36-21. Both tms come into this game with 11 days of rest. MU's pass attack struggled the L/2 gms and their offense is led by RB LaBorn, who is #4 in the FBS with 731 rush (5.5, 8 td), however LA's run defense is allowing just 129 (3.8) and MU has struggled to protect the QB, giving up 17 sks on the season (11.9%). MU has also started QB Colombi in every gm, but bkp Fancher has gotten reps in every gm & comb'd they are hitting 69%. For the Cajuns offense, they are only putting up 315 ypg vs FBS foes and face an MU defense holding tms to 281 ypg/16 ppg and they have recorded 12 sks (7.7%). MU is especially good vs the run, all'g just 71 ypg (2.5) and their pass D ranks #15. The Cajuns have lost 3 straight, but nearly upset SAAla 2 wks ago and MU has not been great as a HF, going just 8-23 ATS in that role since 2016.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 13TH

Baylor at WEST VIRGINIA - As B12 foes the home team has covered 7 of the 10 mtgs, however WVU is just 3-5 ATS as a home underdog. The last mtg here was in 2020 where WVU got past BU in 2OT 27-21 and we picked up a 5★ Sept GOM winner on the Mountaineers! Both tms come into this mtg with nearly 2 full wks of rest. BU is off a home loss vs Okla St while WVU lost at Texas 38-20 and lost stud RB Donaldson (389, 6.9) in that gm and he will not play here. WVU's run game overall could struggle against a BU rush D giving up just 97 ypg (2.8). Overall BU is holding foes to 70 ypg under their ssn avg. While BU's offense is putting up 54 ypg more than their foes allow, WVU boasts a fairly good DEF as they are all'g just 331 ypg and are holding foes to 52 ypg under their ssn avg & the WVU's home crowds are usually pretty good.

Temple at UCF - UCF has won 5 straight in the series (4-1 ATS), incl a 49-7 (-11) win at Temple LY. The Knights should be off a full bye week, but Hurricane Ian forced their home gm vs SMU to be moved from Sat to Wed, so UCF has a few less days rest than expected. The Knights took down SMU 41-19 (-2) in their rescheduled affair. UCF actually trailed 13-10 at HT, but shutout the Mustangs most of the 2H, before all'g a garbage-time TD with 1 second left. Despite all'g a ssn high 476 yds, the Knights Def held SMU to 4 of 16 on 3rd down & 2 of 5 on 4th & are all'g just 14.6 ypg on the yr. Temple comes in at 2-3 SU (2-2 ATS) & is off a bye. The Owls have shown considerable improvement on the Def side of the ball since all'g 500 yds to Duke in week 1, as they have all'd just 258 ypg in their L/4 gms & have recorded 9 sks the last 2 wks. The week off should allow the Owls to coach-up true frosh QB Warner, who has thrown 6 ints since taking over as the starter the L/3 gms.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 14TH

Navy at SMU - SMU has won 3 of 4 SU vs Navy, incl the L/2 in Dallas (2-0 ATS). The Mustangs were scheduled to be off a full bye week, but Hurricane Ian forced their road game vs UCF to be moved from Sat to Wed. SMU fell to 41-19 (+2) to the Knights & have now lost 3 str games (0-3 ATS). The Mustangs controlled the 1H with a 287-145 yd edge, but only led 13-10 & wilted on both sides of the ball in the 2H. SMU all'd 339 yds & 31 pts in the 2H & did not score until a garbage-time TD with 01 left in the 4th. The Mustangs are now all'g 195 rush ypg to FBS foes. Navy is off a dominant 53-21 (+6) home win Tulsa that moved them to 2-3 on the ssn & they have now covered in 3 straight. The Midshipmen triple-option attack finally got untracked as they amassed 455 rush yds (6.6), after avg just 176 rush ypg (3.2 ypc) their 1st 5 gms. The Navy D has shown steady improvement, all'g 345 ypg their L/3 after all'g a ssn high 506 in wk 2. This game poses an interesting dichotomy on Off, as SMU wants to go up tempo & Navy wants to control the clock.

Utsha vs FIU - FIU has won the last 2 meetings including 45-7 as 10' pt dogs in '18 but UTSA is a heavy fav this week. The Roadrunners are coming off a rematch of LY's CUSA Title gm after beating WKU 31-28 (-6) LW. QB Harris has a 13-5 ratio and is their #2 rusher with 254 (4.9). FIU was coming off a rare win last week but lost at home to UConn 33-12. The Panthers only punted twice but had 3 TO's and were SOD on their final 3 drives and finished with a +7 yd edge. The Roadrunners are 12-6 ATS vs CUSA foes under Traylor but are 0-2 ATS when playing 20+ vs FBS foes. FIU is on a 2-16-1 ATS run vs FBS foes.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 15TH

Toledo by 5 over Kent St - Rockets are 12-2 SU in series incl 5 straight wins (4-1 ATS) but HT is 0-2 ATS as UT only won 35-33 last mtg ('19) as a 7 pt HF. KS is 4-3 SU & ATS vs MAC West tms s/'19. LW at half, UT had just a 220-184 yd edge (FD even) but led NIU 35-7 as they had TWO pick-6's & an int in EZ to stop an NIU td right before half. UT led 45-7 into 4Q but allowed NIU to make it 52-32. Kent St 2 wks ago made a big 4Q comeback & beat Ohio in OT. LW they tried to do the same thing vs Miami. They trailed 17-0 1Q & 27-14 into 4Q. After settling for a FG to get within 27-24 they allowed Miami to run out final 6:07. KSU QB Schlee has just 3 int this ssn, so UT will have to score more on offense here. As an over TD AD we look for KSU to keep it closer than that.

Buffalo by 13 over MASSACHUSETTS - Bulls were 3-1 SU & 2-2 ATS vs UMass as MAC foes but 1st meeting since UMass left conf in '15. UMass is just 1-5 SU (only win vs FCS) but they have covered 3 of last 4 incl L/2 ATS incl only losing to MAC foe EM 20-13 (+20) 2 wks ago. Bulls are coming off a dominate 3 star late phone winner for us, cruising past BG 38-7 as a 2 pt AF. Bulls are 3-0 and lead the MAC East race but are in a MAC Sandwich with a big game VS MAC West leader Toledo next week. LW as a 24 pt HD UMass got the backdoor cover td with 4:22 left to only lose 42-24. This week could be much the same as Bulls will want to keep fresh for MAC play & UMass has improved enough to keep it closer than the over 2 td line here.

Alabama by 5 over TENNESSEE - Bama has won 15 straight mtgs (11-4 ATS). LY the Tide only led 31-24 4Q then tacked on 3 td's to cover the 25 pt line. Bama was without Heisman winning QB Bryce Young last week vs A&M. Bkp QB Milroe threw for 3 td's but only 111 yds. Bama continued their recent tradition of playing to the level of their competition, only winning 24-20 as 24 pt chalk. 7 of their last 12 games vs P5 foes have been decided by 7 pts or less. RB Gibbs has stepped up w/206 and 154 the L2W but faces a Tenn D that allows just 89 rush ypg (2.8) led by DE Byron Young (4.5 tfl, 10 QBH). QB Hooker has a 41-3 ratio since taking over LY and faces our #5 pass D. The Vols avg 548 ypg and they've put up the most yards all 5 opponents have allowed. If Young returns he would find success against a Tenn D that is allowing 307 pass ypg and may be w/o S McCollough (#4 tklr) who was arrested on Sunday. Bama seems to play to the level of their competition against Power 5 foes so we will call for the Tide to win yet another close game and will keep an eye on Young's status.

Georgia by 41 over Vanderbilt - UGA has won the last 4 mtgs by 36 ppg including a 62-0 (-36) beatdown in Nashville and they finished w/a 532-77 yd edge. The Dawgs were w/o star NT Jalen Carter last week vs Aub. They only led 14-0 at H and 35-10 4Q but scored w/4:45 to cover 28'. Vandy gave Ole Miss a mild run LW, leading 20-10 2Q. Vandy gave up a td with :18 left for a front door cover, losing 52-28 (-17). True frosh QB Swann has an 8-0 ratio including 2 td's LW but he had a rough outing at Bama when he threw for just 115. UGA is +255 ypg while Vandy is -100 ypg vs similar sked strength. The Dawgs avg 518 ypg and have put up the most yds all 5 foes have allowed while Vandy is allowing 55 ypg more than their foes avg. Vandy is 8-3 as away dogs but the 'Dores already have a 52 pt loss at Bama this year.

Miami, FIU by 10 over VIRGINIA TECH - UM is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series and won LY 38-26 as a 7' pt HF. Both tms enter on 3 game losing streaks. LW VT lost at Pitt, who was missing 2 starting OL and their top 2 WR's, 45-29 (+14). They allowed 326 rush (7.6). They did only trail 31-29 4Q. UM was -3' at home vs NCar LW. QB Van Dyke threw for 496 and 3 td's but threw his only int in their final drive. UM punted just twice the entire gm but missed a fg, was SOD twice and had 3 TO's. UM is +107 ypg while VT is -7 ypg and the Hokies have only ply'd a slightly tougher sked. VT is playing for their 7th straight week while UM had a bye 2 wks ago. Both tms are desperate for a win but the 'Canes have more talent and we will take Van Dyke (64%, 7-4) over VT's Grant Wells (59%, 6-7). VT is also 4-7 as home dogs s/'17.

Mississippi St by 7 over KENTUCKY - The home team is 7-0 SU/ATS in this series. MSU is off a 40-17 (-9) win over Ark who was w/o QB Jefferson. Rogers has a 22-3 ratio and threw for 395 last week. KY was w/o QB Levis last week and lost 24-14 to SCar at home as 6' pt chalk. The 'Cats were held to 299 yds and they've rushed for just 93 ypg (2.7) with their Oline allowing 25 sacks (14.9%) including 6 LW. KY's pass D is allowing just 53.3% but Rogers completed an SEC record 36 of 39 passes for an SEC record 92% (min 30 pass att) in last year's 31-17 win (E). Miss St had a 438-216 yd edge. The Bulldogs have ply'd the tougher sked (#12 vs #42) and have a big edge on offense, especially if Levis is unavailable. KY is 4-0 as a home dog but 0-4 ATS off a SU loss.

North Carolina by 10 over DUKE - HC Mack Brown is 11-0 SU in two stints at North Carolina. Duke has lost the last two meetings by 32 & 31 pts and the visitor has covered 4 of the L/5. NC is off a 27-24 (+3) win at Miami which was their 2nd road upset this ssn. Duke started the ssn 3-0 but has lost 2 of the last 3 including LW at GTech 23-20. The Blue Devils were outg'd 412-278 and trailed 20-6 4Q but scored 2 td's in the final 5:55 to force OT. QB Maye leads one of the top pass offenses in the country with a 21-3 ratio. NC's pass D has been one of the worst in the nation but they have held their last 2 foes under 100 rush yds. Duke's D is allowing 28 ypg more than their foes avg. The Heels have owned this series under Brown and we see no reason to think different, which has us giving NC a 10 pt edge.

FLORIDA by 5 over Lsu - LSU is 9-3 SU and covered 7 of the L/8 mtgs. LY UF was out for revenge for the shoe throw game in '20 when LSU won on a 56 yd fg as 23' pt dogs which ruined Florida's chances to make their first playoff. The Tigers upset UF for the 2nd straight ssn last year, 49-42 as 12' pt dogs. The Gators enter off a 24-17 (-11) win over Mizzou. UF was outgained 370-297 but did have a 14 pt lead until Mizzou scored with 5:58 left. Slow starts have plagued LSU who fell behind 20-0 2Q last week as 3 pt home dogs vs Tenn in a 40-13 loss and they also fell behind vs FSU 17-3 and at Aub 17-0 1H. FL played that same Tenn team and only lost by 5 a few weeks ago. Both teams enter 4-2 with first year head coaches and dual threat QB's who have had disappointing starts to their ssn. We think LSU has another slow start and will take the Gators to win by over a fg.

Maryland by 10 over INDIANA - IND owns a 5-3 SU/ATS edge in the series & has won 3 of the L/4 (3-1 ATS), but MD did win at home 38-35 (-4) LY. IU is off a 31-10 (+22) home loss to MICH, in which they were held to 29 tll yds in the 2H after being tied 10-10 at HT. (IND has now lost 3 straight games by an avg of 19 ppg, while all'g 37 ppg in that span. MD comes in at 4-2 SU/ATS after their 31-29 (-3) home loss to PUR. The Terps out'd PUR 387-373 & held the Boilers to just 13 yds rushing - & also produced 5 sks. MD scored a TD with 35 secs left 4Q but were forced to go for 2 for the tie and didn't convert. MD is in unfamiliar territory here, as they have only been a DD conf AF once since joining the BIG10 in 2014, so with that in mind we see this one right near the line.

Nc State by 1 over SYRACUSE - NCSU is 13-2 SU in this series and has won 3 straight. They won 41-17 (-11) with a 399-236 yd edge. Last week we used the Wolfpack as our 4★ top LPS and caught some bad luck late with QB Leary getting inj'd and NCSU passed on a chance to kick a fg that would have given us the cover, instead punting from the FSU35. Cuse enters fresh off a bye and are 5-0 but their schedule toughens up now. The 'Pack have the edge on D, holding foes 119 ypg below their avg and LB's Thomas and Wilson are among the best in the ACC. They are allowing just 112 rush ypg (4.0) and face RB Tucker who has struggled outside of a 232 yd performance vs lowly FCS Wagner. Cuse QB Shrader has a 10-1 ratio but NCSU's #6 ranked pass D (57%, 5-9) will be his toughest test. We think the D steps up in the likely absence of Leary and leads NCSU to a close win.

BALL ST by 6 over Connecticut - Ball St is 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS in series but dog has covered L/2. Last met in '02 a 24-21 Ball St OT win as a 6 pt AD. LW Ball St defense held LY's FBS rush leader Lew Nichols to just 3.1 ypc & after the offense had been stopped on a 4th&g, had a 4 yd FR for a td to lead 14-10 3Q lead. After CM took a 16-14 lead (missed XP), Cardinals hit FG with 12:14 left to lead 17-16 & the defense did the rest. Both tms come in 3-3 SU as UConn after not beating an FBS foe s'19, has now beat two in b2b wks as they led FIU 20-0 at HT with a 241-169 yd edge & cruised to a 33-12 win as a 5' pt AF. Huskies are 3-1 ATS on the road TY & 4 of Ball St's last 5 wins over FBS foes has been by 7 pts or less, we look for UConn to keep it inside the number.

Central Michigan by 15 over AKRON - CM is 11-2 SU & 9-4 ATS vs Akron s'98. Both come in 1-5 SU & 2-4 ATS with their only win over an FCS team. While many expected that for Akron, few did for CM. LW CM had 2 big mistakes giving up a 4 yd FR td & missing an XP that led to a 17-16 loss to Ball St. LW Akron as a 10' pt AD trailed Ohio 48-20 into the 4Q & lost 55-34. CM has the edge on both Offense (#88-#116) & Defense (#96-#127). While it is hard to lean with a 2 td road favorite, CM is better than their record, have their backs to the wall and are facing a team that is being outscored by 23 ppg, is allowing 483 ypg incl 192 ypg rush & 4.9 ypc.

Purdue by 7 over Nebraska - Nebraska has won 5 of 9 in the series since 2013, but Purdue is 6-3 ATS in those mtgs, incl an outright 28-23 (+7) upset LY in Lincoln, which was the 3rd straight upset in the series. A week after getting an upset win at MIN, PUR was back on the road at MARY last week. The Boilers pulled out a narrow 31-29 (+3) victory after stopping a MARY 2 pt conv att with 35 secs left, for their 3rd straight win which moved them to 4-2 (3-3 ATS) on the ssn. QB O'Connell threw for 360 yds & 2 TDs. The PUR Def has been stout against the run in B10 play, all'g just 72 ypg (2.6) to conf foes. NEB moved to 2-1 under interim HC Joseph after their 14-13 (-3) win at Rutgers. In 2 gms since their bye, their Def is all'g just 319 ypg after all'g 583 ypg in their previous 3 gms vs FBS foes. NEB has an additional bye on deck, which puts their focus solely on a PUR team that has only been a DD favorite once in the series. The Huskers are 9-4 as an AD while the Boilermakers are 4-10 as a HF and we have NEB staying within a td.

Clemson by 8 over FLORIDA ST - Clem has won the last 6 mtgs (4-2 ATS) including LY 30-20 (-9), getting the cover when DT Bresee recovered a fumble in the EZ while FSU was trying a lateral play. The Tigers shut BD down LW in a 30-3 win and their D is starting to play like expected, holding both NCSU and BC under 300 yds and they've held FSU to 243 ypg in the L/4 mtgs. It was only 10-3 at half and Clem scored 2 td's in the 4Q. FSU led NCSU 17-3 at half LW but lost 19-17 (+3). FSU avg 204 rush ypg (5.6) while Clem allows just 64 (2.2) and hasn't allowed over 3.7 ypc yet this ssn. These two have ply'd 3 common foes (NCSU/BC/WF) with Clem going 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS, +15 ppg & +66 ypg while FSU is 1-2 SU/2-1 ATS, +6 ppg but +121 ypg. The home crowd will be fired up, but we see Clemson getting the road win by just over a td.

EAST CAROLINA by 11 over Memphis - ECU is 8-2 SU/ATS in the series since 2006, but both of those losses have come in the last 3 meetings. The Pirates did win 30-29 (+4) in OT at MEM LY as they outg'd the Tigers 502-341. ECU comes in at 3-3 (4-2 ATS) after their 24-9 (+3) loss at Tulane & have lost 2 of their L/3. The Pirates only trailed 14-9 at HT, but were shutout in the 2H, as QB Ahlers threw 2 costly int's. MEM is off a 33-32 (-3) home loss vs HOU, which ended their 4 gm win streak & moved them to 4-2 (3-3 ATS) on the yr. The Tigers led 20-7 heading into the 4Q, but all'd 26 4Q pts, incl 2 TDs in the L/2 mins, incl the GW with just 18 secs left. Their banged up OL has now all'd 12 sks the L/3 wks. MEM heads out on the road for the first time in over a month, after 4 straight home gms & are just 1-9 ATS on the road under HC Silverfield, so we'll side with the Pirates in this one.

Tulane by 14 over USF - Tulane leads the series 2-1 (3-0 ATS), incl a 45-14 (-5) home win LY. TUL moved to 5-1 SU/ATS on the ssn, after a 24-9 (-3) home win vs ECU, in which they were outg'd

419-391, but managed to pitch a 2H shutout. The Green Wave Def has been solid overall, limiting FBS tms to 16 ppg, while the Off has been efficient under the direction of QB Pratt (68%, 9-3 ratio), who returned here after missing 2 wks ago w/inj. USF has lost 4 straight gms after their (+27) loss at CIN. The Bulls actually led 17-14 at HT, with 221-162 ydg & 13-8 FD edges, but were held to 124 yds in the 2H & failed to muster much Off after the Bearcats took the lead with just over 9 mins left. Despite the solid effort in this one, the USF D is all'g 39.6 ppg & 487 ypg to FBS foes. Their lone win (1-5 SU, 2-4 ATS) is over FCS Howard & HC Jeff Scott is now just 4-23 SU during his tenure at USF. Tulane has won & covered both of their road gms TY & we like them to continue that trend here against a Bulls team that has been outscored by an avg of 24.5 ppg in their 2 home games.

Minnesota by 1 over ILLINOIS - MIN has won 5 of the L/7, but ILL pulled the outright upset on the road LY, with a 14-6 (+14) win that derailed MIN's B10 West Title aspirations. The Illini come in at 5-1 (4-2 ATS) on the ssn after their 9-6 (-3) home win against Iowa, as they held them to just 222 yds. The ILL D has been stifling all year & has the #1 scoring Def in the country all'g just 8.0 ppg, and they have racked up 19 sks in that span. The Illini rushing attack has been formidable as RB Chase Brown is #1 in the B10 at 147 rush ypg. QB Devito did go down with an ankle inj in the 1Q & did not return (CS). MIN is off a bye & needed the extra time to get healthy, as RB Ibrahim (#2 in B10, 141.8 ypg) missed the prvs week's 20-10 home loss to PUR. Despite the loss, MIN still have the #2 scoring D in the FBS, all'g just 8.8 ppg. The Illini are in the midst of a tough 3 game stretch that had them facing WISC & Iowa the L/2 wks & now face a refreshed MIN team, but it is impossible for us to lean against ILL at this point, so while we think MIN will win, we like ILL to cover.

Miami, Oh by 14 over BOWLING GREEN - Outright winner has covered 18 straight with favorite winning L/3 and the Home team is just 3-8 but has won L/2. LY Miami only led 20-7 at HT as a 17 pt AF but outscored BG 14-0 in 2H. LW we won a 3 star late phone selection going against the Falcons as a 2 pt HD & they trailed Buffalo 38-0 mid-3Q & lost 38-7 being outgained 466-380. The week prior Miami had lost to that same UB team on the road 24-20 despite a 359-278 yd edge. LW Miami kept their MAC East hopes alive as after leading Kent St 24-7 early 3Q they held on for the 27-24 upset as a 5' pt HD. While almost identical on offense (BG #113-#114), Miami has a big edge on defense (#73-#119). Already having a loss to MAC East leader Buffalo, the RedHawks have no margin for error in MAC play, we look for them to take care of business here by 2 td's.

Northern Illinois by 3 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Huskies are 18-3 SU but just 11-10 ATS & had lost 2 straight SU & ATS in series before LY's 27-20 win (E). The week after trailing UMMSU 13-0 early, EM burst from the gate & led rival WM 35-7 with 17-8 FD & 351-104 yd edges at HT. They cruised to a 45-23 win as a 6 pt AD. Returning MAC Champ NIU is all but out of the MAC West race after 2 straight losses. The week after blowing 21-0 & 38-28 4Q leads & missing GW FG in OT, NIU self destructed again with 4 int's, two that were returned for td's in 1H & another was in EZ as they trailed Toledo 35-7 despite only being outgained 220-184 (FD even) in the 1H. They showed life in 4Q but led 52-32 as a 5' pt HD. While the Eagles excel as the dog, they struggle as a favorite, being just 2-8 ATS as a HF (0-3 TY) incl a 50-31 loss to Buffalo as a 6' pt 3 weeks ago. NIU is 11-4 ATS (2-0 TY) as an AD under HC Hammock & we will take the points here.

COASTAL CAROLINA by 6 over Old Dominion - Only prior mtg came in '12 as FCS foes and ODU blew out CC 63-35. CC is off a 28-21 win at ULM, but are playing for a 7th straight wk while ODU has the benefit of coming off a bye. CC comes into this game avg'g 459 ypg/35 ppg and the Monarchs defense is all'g 45.2 ypg on the year, but ODU is +5 TO's on the ssn. ODU also has 17 sks in their L/4 gms. While ODU's offense is putting up 54 ypg less than their foes allow (#112) their pass attack is led by WR Jennings (688, 21.5) & CC has the #116 pass D. CC is just 1-9 ATS in their L/10 games as a DD favorite and are on a 3-7 ATS slide against SBC foes as a HF. ODU also has the big schedule edge (#41 vs #119). CC is just 1 of 2 unbeaten non-P5 tms left & they will get the win here but ODU has played close gms TY & we think they keep this one to within a TD.

SOUTHERN MISS by 6 over Arkansas St - SMISS has won 9 of the 11 mtgs but 1st as SBC foes & haven't met since 2008. Ark St (42-20 loss vs JMU) and SMISS (27-10 loss at Troy) both failed to cover for the 1st time LW. SMISS's offense is getting held to 80 ypg less than their foes allow (#118) while Ark St's offense has only put up 347 ypg the L/4 gms. SMISS is -150 ypg/-9 ppg vs FBS foes, while Ark St is -128 ypg/-10 ppg vs FBS foes but Ark St has played the slightly tougher sked (#66 vs #82). Ark St's OL is a concern as they have all'd 16 sks the L/3 gms & SMISS has 16 sks the L/4 gms. Ark St is also playing for a 7th straight week, while this is SMISS's 2nd gm off a bye. SMISS's toughest gms have been on the road vs tough DEF's, but are 4-1 ATS and now are at home vs an Ark St DEF that is allowing foes to gain 52 ypg above their ssn avg (#114 FBS).

BYU by 3 over Arkansas - Both tms limp into this non-conf showdown with injuries and off a loss. Ark was w/o QB KJ Jefferson LW and lost at Miss St 40-17 (+9). Cade Fortin started but HC Pittman turned to dual threat Malik Hornsby who sparked the offense. Hornsby threw for 234 and rushed for 114 but did throw 2 int's. BYU QB Jaren Hall was not 100% in their 28-20 (+4) loss to Notre Dame according to HC Sitake. BYU trailed 25-6 3Q but did get within 5 and were SOD at the ND27 on their final drive. BYU did allow 234 rush (5.2) LW and Ark puts up 234 rush (4.8) on the ssn. BYU went into Knoxville and beat Tenn back in '19. Now they have the elevation edge against an Ark team that has lost their last 3 trips out west so we like the Cougars to win by a fg.

Over 40 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 39 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years. Here is This week's Underdog Play:

Iowa St +14' over TEXAS

Iowa St (+) over TEXAS - ISU has won 3 straight vs Texas and going back to '15 the 'Under' has hit 7 times with an avg of 34 pts scored. Texas got QB Ewers back LW and over their L/4 gms Texas is avg'g 479 ypg/41 ppg but here they run into an ISU defense holding foes to 149 ypg under their ssn avg (#4 FBS!) and allow just 14 ppg. ISU's offense has struggled to move the ball in B12 play as they are avg'g just 313 ypg/15 ppg & the UT defense is holding foes to 136 ypg under their ssn avg (#7 FBS!) but all 3 of ISU's B12 games this ssn have been decided by 7 pts or less. While Texas has looked impressive TY & now has their QB back to go with star RB Robinson but ISU HC Campbell is 8-4-1 ATS as an AD since 2017 & overall is 8-1-ATS as a DD dog vs B12 foes and Texas is coming off a big win, so we think ISU can keep this game within the line. **FORECAST: TEXAS by 6**

California by 18 over COLORADO - Former WKU HC and current Buffs OC Mike Sanford takes over in Boulder as the interim HC following the firing of Karl Dorrell and DC Chris Wilson (0-5 SU/ATS, 32 pt avg loss). The Bears also return from their bye sitting at 3-2 on the year (24-9 defeat in Pullman the week prior). In LY's meeting the Buffs were held to just 13 yds in the 2H of an eventual 26-3 defeat in Berkeley. While the HT has won each of the past 5 meetings (3-1-1 ATS), it's hard to get behind the Buffs considering how bad they have looked. Also keep in mind that Cal has gone a solid 16-7 on the road dating back to the end of the '17 ssn.

UTAH by 10 over Usc - Key matchup inside of the P12 between the undefeated Trojans who moved to 6-0 LW following a 30-14 win over Wash St (outscored Cougs 13-0 in 2H, USC 23-17 FD & 369-316 yd edges) and the Utes who suffered their 1st loss since the opener LW in Pasadena (Utah 31-21 FD edge). In their meeting a year ago, the Utes (+3) led 35-10 heading into the 4Q of an eventual 16 pt upset win at the Coliseum. With the HT an impressive 7-2 SU (6-3 ATS) in this series and the Trojans going 1-8 ATS as an AD over the past 6 years, we expect the Utes (19-8 ATS in P12) to pick up the much-needed victory.

OREGON ST by 5 over Washington St - Following a rough 2-game part of their schedule where they fell by 3 at home to USC and were blasted on the road by Utah, the Beavers narrowly got back on track LW in Palo Alto against the Cardinal without starting QB Nolan (Ben Gulbranson 20-28-250-2-0 incl GW 56-yd TD pass w/13 left!). The Cougars meanwhile suffered their 2nd defeat of the ssn LW against USC with their offense being held scoreless in the 2H. While OSU went 6-1 vs WSU from '07-'13, the Cougs have now picked up 8 straight wins (6-2 ATS) including a 31-24 (+4) win LY in Pullman. Oregon St has an outstanding 8-1 ATS mark as a HF and are +72 ypg on the ssn and +129 ypg at home while Wash St is -5 ypg on the ssn and -101 ypg on the road.

WASHINGTON by 14 over Arizona - After a rough home effort against the Ducks where they were outgained 580-356 in a 27 pt defeat, the Wildcats (10-25 ATS as an AD) head North to take on a Huskies team that suffered a shocking 45-38 defeat in Tempe (-13') despite 32-23 FD and 458-397 yd edges (RB Davis 3 rush TD's). UW has won 5 straight (3-2 ATS) in this series including LY when they scored 14 unanswered points in the 4Q to escape Tucson with a 21-16 win (-17'). While the HT has covered 4 of the L/5, the Huskies are just 4-12 ATS in conf matchups giving the Wildcats a chance to stay within the line.

San Jose St by 9 over FRESNO ST - As MW foes these tms have split the 8 gms SU and SJSt is 4-3-1 ATS. Fresno is dealing with inj's to several key s'trs incl QB Haener and LW against Boise they trailed 20-17 HT but were held to 3 pts & 45 yds in 2H & lost 40-20 (4★ LP Winner on Boise!) while SJSt hosted UNLV and blew them out 40-7 (+220 yds). SJSt's DEF has been strong all ssn, holding foes to 92 ypg under their ssn avg and have held their L/3 foes to under 255 yds. SJSt's offense has picked it up lately as well, as they gained 433 yds LW & QB Cordeiro totaled 339 yds (230 pass, 109 rush). Fresno's offense vs UConn struggled (187 ttl yds) and LW vs Boise they had 233 yds. SJSt comes into this matchup looking like a legit contender for the MW crown, while Fresno has yet to win a game vs an FBS foe this season & are 0-5 ATS while SJSt is 4-0 ATS vs FBS foes this season. Check the status on Fresno's inj's esp QB Haener, but if he is out we like SJSt by over a TD.

TROY by 21 over Texas St - As SBC foes Troy has dominated this series, going 7-0 SU/5-2 ATS with just 2 gms being decided by less than 14 pts. Troy is back at home again after facing SMiss LW where they won 27-10 & held SMiss to 205 yds while TXSt is off a monumental upset of App St at home. Troy comes in avg'g 315 pass ypg & while they face a TXSt defense that in their L/3 gms vs FBS foes has all'd 469 ypg. Troy also boasts a strong DEF that is holding foes to 113 ypg under their ssn avg (#11 FBS) and TXSt is avg'g just 315 ypg vs FBS foes. Troy's pass rush has 15 sks the L/3 gms and TXSt has all'd 15 sks on the ssn. In their L/7 road losses TXSt is just 2-5 ATS and those losses are by an avg of 28 pgs. Troy is also 6-0 ATS this season & we think they cruise to an easy win here over a TXSt team that could be in for a letdown after such a big win LW.

MISSISSIPPI by 11 over Auburn - Aub is 12-3 SU/10-5 ATS in Oxford. Ole Miss has lost the last 4 home mtgs outright. LY Ole Miss trailed 31-20 4Q and was int'd in the EZ and SOD on their final 2 drives. The Rebels enter 6-0 but they've played an extremely soft sked (#89) with just 1 win over a P5 team with a winning record. LW they were -17 yet trailed Vandy 20-10 2Q and were out FD'd 12-10 in the 1H. They scored 21 unanswered in the 3Q and up 17, scored with just 18 left for a front door cover. Aub hung tough with UGA last week, only trailing 14-0 H and were covering until UGA tacked on a late td w/4:45 left for a 42-10 (-28') win. Aub did lead Mizzou 14-0 1Q and LSU 17-0 2Q the two wks prior but have struggled in the 2H, getting outscored 125-31 in their last 9 gms. Aub hasn't been a dog to Ole Miss s/'15 and now they are getting 15' pts. They are more battle tested and if they have their typical strong start we see them staying within the opening line.

SOUTH ALABAMA by 21 over ULM - SAIA is 3-5 SU vs ULM as SBC foes by are 5-3 ATS. SAIA won't overlook ULM TY as they were upset LY by the Warhawks 41-31 as 13'-pt road chalk. All 6 of ULM's wins under HC Bowden have come at home, and on the road in SBC gms under Bowden ULM is -121 ypg/-21 ppg and SAIA is +99 ypg/+14 ppg at home vs FBS foes under Wommack & are also 5-0 ATS at home vs FBS foes dating back to LY. The ULM offense is getting held to 46 ypg less than their foes allow (#108) and SAIA's strong DEF is holding foes to 79 ypg under their ssn avg (#22) & they are +7 TO's on the season. SAIA's offense is also putting up 432 ypg/35 ppg TY. Both tms played close gms vs LA, but SAIA won on the road while ULM needed a 2H comeback to win at home (down 10 pts HT). Twice LY after ULM covered at home as a DD dog the following week were blown out on the road by an SBC foe & we think that happens again here & take the Jags by 3 td's.

OKLAHOMA by 3 over Kansas - OU has won 17 straight vs KU (10-7 ATS). However OU is off to an 0-3 start in B12 play for the 1st time s/1998 after a 49-0 loss to Texas where they were outgained 585-195. QB Gabriele DNP LW (concussion) and his status is ? as of presstime. KU lost their 1st gm of the ssn LW at home vs TCU 38-31 where they lost QB Daniels to inj (check status) but bkp QB Bean led 4 2H td drives (262, 67%, 4-1). KU did also hold TCU to 98 yds under their ssn avg while OU all'd TCU to gain 173 yds above their ssn avg. OU's DEF is also all'g 587 ypg/48 ppg to B12 foes TY, but KU is all'g 435 ypg vs FBS foes. While OU looks like they can't be trusted to win a game right now, KU did lose their playmaking QB last week & his status is ? as of presstime so we'll call for OU to finally get a Big 12 win, but only by a fg as this KU team looks legit.

Oklahoma St by 1 over TCU - As B12 foes the home team is 8-2 SU/ATS & 5 outright upsets have occurred. OSU is off a 41-31 win vs TT while TCU snapped KU's unbeaten run with a 38-31 win. OSU is winning gms TY with offense (469 ypg/46 ppg) led by QB Sanders (1394, 61%, 12-2) as their D is all'g foes to gain 74 ypg above their ssn avg (#121). TCU is also winning w/ offense as they are avg'g 505 ypg/43 ppg led by QB Duggan (1305, 73%, 14-1) & their D is giving up 448 ypg vs B12 foes. While TCU is 4-0-1 ATS this season & are +127 ypg/+23 ppg, OSU's veteran HC Gundy is an impressive 13-5-1 ATS vs ranked tms s/'18. OSU is also on a 5-0 ATS run in B12 road gms & overall are on a 10-1 ATS run vs B12 foes in the regular ssn. While we've been impressed with TCU's start, we'll back the veteran coach and QB to lead OSU to a win, in what should be a high-scoring game.

WESTERN MICHIGAN by 7 over Ohio - WM is 7-2 SU & 6-3 ATS vs Ohio s/2000 & last met in '19 when WM (E) won 37-34 in OT. LW WM was dominated by Em in the 1H, trailing 21-0 early 2Q & 35-7 at HT being outgained 351-104 & out FD's 17-8 & never recovered losing 45-23 as a 6 pt HF. LW Ohio led Akron 48-20 into the 4Q as a 10' pt HF cruising to a 55-34 win. Ohio has the offensive edge (#71-#112) but WM has the defensive edge (#109-#129). In fact Ohio's defense allowed 34 pts & 478 yds to an Akron team that had been avg just 15 ppg & 321 ypg. In fact Ohio's road defense is last in the FBS allowing foes 161 ypg over their season average. We look for the Broncos offense that put up 44 pts vs New Hampshire 2 wks ago to put up similar numbers here.

UAB by 28 over Charlotte - First mtg s/'18 which UAB won 28-7 (-16). The Blazers won us a 2★ on these pages LW, beating Middle Tenn 41-14 (-9). They led 38-7 at half w/a 439-130 yd edge. CLT is fresh off a bye but come in just 1-5 and are -160 ypg. The 49ers D is allowing 538 ypg including 253 (5.8) on the ground and foes are putting up 137 ypg more than they avg. UAB avg 237 rush ypg led by RB's McBride (641, 7.4) and Brown (378, 7.1). UAB has a huge edge on D, holding foes 92 ypg below their avg and they allow just 318 ypg. CLT has 3 losses of 30+ this ssn. The Blazers are now 21-7-2 ATS at home and we see no reason to against them so we have UAB winning by 4 td's.

NORTH TEXAS by 13 over Louisiana Tech - LT has won the L/4 mtgs but NT did cover LY as 11 pt dogs and had a 333-286 yd edge. HC Cumbie won his CUSA opener LW 41-31 (-2) despite getting outgained 501-380. LT led 20-3 2Q, but up 23-10 they got a pick 6 then UTEP fumbled at the goal line then the Miners were SOD on their first 2 poss' of the 2H. The Mean Green are off a bye and beat FAU 45-28 the week prior. NT is avg 476 ypg and puts up 67 ypg more than their foes allow on avg. They are +13 ypg while LT -82 and the Mean Green has a solid edge on offense and ST's. DC Bennett has NT's D improving after they gave up over 450 yds in 3 straight they held Memphis to 334 and FAU to 432. NT has won & cov'd their L/3 CUSA home games and we like them here to win by nearly 2 td's.

FAU by 3 over Rice - Rice won the last meeting back in '16 42-25 but make their first trip to Boca Raton in '15. The home team is 1-2 SU/0-3 ATS. FAU has lost 3 straight including at NT as 3 pt road chalk before their bye. Rice has covered 4 straight including two outright upsets at home over Louisiana and UAB though they were outgained by 151 yds against the Blazers. The Owls also kept it close at Houston as 17' pt dogs, only losing 34-27. FAU is 10-3 SU at home so we think the Owls win this game, but Rice has been a surprising team that keeps games close so we are cutting our lean off at a fg.

Nevada by 1 over HAWAII - Since '12 Nev is 7-3 SU/ATS vs UH. Neither tm comes into this matchup with much success as Nev is just 2-4 on the ssn & are avg'g just 293 ypg on offense and are getting help from their DEF (+9 TO's). UH is winless vs FBS foes TY and are avg'g 318 ypg/17 ppg on offense while the DEF is all'g foes to gain 114 ypg above their ssn avg (#130 FBS). UH is also -152 ypg/24 ppg while Nev is -95 ypg/ but just -6 ppg. Nev does have a big ST edge (#34 vs #91). The 'Under' has hit in the L/9 mtgs with an avg of 51 pts scored. These are 2 of the worst MW teams, but Nev has shown a little more fight this season and we'll take them to win a close game but will side with the home team to get the cover as we don't trust Nev as a road favorite.

Utah St by 13 over COLORADO ST - USU has won the L/3 mtgs SU but have only covered 1 of the L/5 mtgs. While CSU finally got their 1st win under HC Norvell LW at Nev, their DEF was responsible for both td's and the Rams offense is only avg'g 244 ypg & they are gaining 111 ypg less than their foes allow (#130 FBS). USU got their 1st MW win LW in a home upset of AF 34-27 where QB Legas threw for 215 (78%, 2-1) and the DEF held AF to 102 yds under their ssn avg. USU is all'g just 369 ypg the L/4 gms & CSU's DEF is all'g 30 ypg more than their foes allow (#105 FBS). We still don't trust CSU at all as LW's gm was 2 bad football teams facing off & we like the Aggies to keep their momentum going and get the win here by nearly 2 td's.

NOTRE DAME by 24 over Stanford - While the Cardinal finally snapped their ATS losing streak at 11 straight LW at home against the Beavers. OSU and their bkp QB were still able to overcome a 24-10 deficit in the 4Q on an eventual 28-27 victory (SU QB McKee 20-33-269-2-1). Stanford now heads into South Bend to take on an Irish squad that picked up an 8 pt win over BYU a week ago in Las Vegas with TE Mayer pulling in 11 rec for 118 yds and 2 TD's (ND 24-13 FD & 496-280 yd edges). In LY's meeting the Irish (-20) led 24-0 at HT and 38-7 in the 4Q in the eventual 31 pt victory (27-11 FD & 510-227 yd edges). With the HT winning 7 of the past 10 coming in and the Irish having just UNLV on deck, the Cardinal may be in for another long afternoon.

Air Force by 13 over UNLV - AF has won the L/4 mtgs SU and LY won easily vs UNLV 48-14 where they ran for 511 yds (7.4). AF is coming off their 2nd MW loss, as they were upset at USU 34-27 while UNLV suffered their first MW loss LW at SJSt 40-7. AF still leads the FBS with 352 rush ypg (6.1) and UNLV just all'd 203 rush (5.6) LW. UNLV did also lose QB Brumfield (1231, 68%, 8-2) early in the SJSt gm to a head inj (check status) and their offense only put up 213 yds LW and AF holds foes to 43 ypg under their ssn avg & are all'g just 301 ypg on the season. UNLV also has all'd 18 sks (9.6%) and could now be with their bkp QB. We like AF to bounce back with a near 2 td win.

4★ San Francisco over ATLANTA - The 49ers head across the country for a 2nd straight week following an easy 22 pt win LW in Charlotte where we picked up 3★ LP and 4★ Newsletter Winners! While ATL did drop a 6 pt contest a week ago in Tampa (26-19 FD & 420-261 yd deficits), they have covered all 5 of their games so far in '22 including a pair of upsets against SEA and CLE. In their Bay Area trip a ssn ago, the Falcons (+9) had substantial FD (23-13) and yard (397-275) deficits in the 18 pt defeat. With just a 2-7 ATS mark in home matchups dating back to LY for the Falcons and SF covering 10 of their past 14 overall, we're giving the visitor a DD edge. **FORECAST: San Francisco by 14**

3★ INDIANAPOLIS over Jacksonville - Double-revenge time for the Colts in this one as they welcome a Jags team that has picked up 2 consec outright upset wins dating back to LY's ssn finale (IND outscored 50-11 in the 2 losses). In their Wk 2 matchup, the Jags (+3) picked up the shutout victory with 21-9 FD and 331-218 yd edges. JAX did struggle LW at home however as the Texans picked up a 13-6 win (+7) cashing a 2★ Newsletter Winner! The Colts meanwhile have extra rest returning home after a surprising 12-9 comeback win in OT against DEN in what could go down as the ugliest primetime game in NFL history. Despite recent history and a 1-6 ATS mark as a DIV HF coming in, it's now or never for the Colts in this one against a Jaguars squad that's failed to cover 22 of their past 32 as an AD. **FORECAST: INDIANAPOLIS by 10**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ KANSAS CITY over Buffalo - While the Bills did pick up a 38-20 victory in LY's regular ssn as a 3 pt dog, the Chiefs have won when it mattered with an AFC Championship victory back in '20 and a DIV Rnd OT win a year ago. The Chiefs (8-4 ATS run as of presstime) are back inside of Arrowhead for the 2nd straight wk although they do play this matchup on short rest after a MNF tilt with the Raiders. The Bills are sitting at 4-1 this ssn following a home blowout of the Steelers where QB Allen finished with 466 ttl yds and 4 TD's. While the vengeful Bills are on a solid 20-9 ATS run overall, this will mark the first time that Patrick Mahomes is a HD in his career! **FORECAST: KANSAS CITY by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

Washington at CHICAGO - Thursday - This marks the only HG in a 5-wk span for the Bears who return to the "Windy City" following a 7 pt road loss at MIN where they had 29-14 FD and 429-271 yd deficits. The Commanders meanwhile were held out of the EZ late in a 4 pt loss (3★ Newsletter Winner on TEN, QB Wentz int'd from the 2 w/06 left). In their most recent matchup back in '19, the Bears (-5) FINALLY ended a 7-game losing skid to WAS that went all the way back to '04. While CHI has covered just 4 of their L/12 overall, the Commanders have dropped 4 straight (SU & ATS) since their ssn-opening win. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Tampa Bay by 10 over PITTSBURGH - After ending their 2-game losing skid a week ago at home against the Falcons where QB Brady threw for 351 yds and a TD, the Bucs head North to take on a Steelers squad that dropped their 4th consec contest LW in BUF (Bills 400 yds at HT w/a 31-3 lead, rookie QB Pickett 34-52-327-0-1 in 1st career start). While the Steelers have won 9 of the 11 all-time meetings against the Bucs including a 30-27 road win in '18, those were without Tom Brady under center in Tampa. During his time in Foxboro, Brady went an outstanding 9-3 overall against PIT (312 ypg, 68%, 29-5). With the Bucs going 7-3-2 ATS vs AFC foes coming in and the Steelers failing to cover their last 7 non-conf matchups, the visitor gets the edge in this one.

NEW ORLEANS by 3 over Cincinnati - The Saints ended their 3-gm losing skid LW in the Superdome against the Seahawks with Taysom Hill finishing with 4 combined TD's. The Bengals meanwhile saw the Ravens get a 43-yd FG as time expired for a 19-17 victory (BAL 325-291 yd edge). In their last meeting back in '18, the Saints (-5) finished with 33-13 FD and 509-284 yd edges in the easy 51-14 victory. While this is a homecoming of sorts for Joe Burrow who won the Heisman with LSU back in '19, the Bengals have failed to cover 6 of their past 9 as a NDIV AF which might not bode well against the Saints.

New England by 1 over CLEVELAND - Following a 29-0 win against the Lions LW in Foxboro (DET led NFL avg 35.0 ppg), the Patriots head into CLE to take on a Browns squad that blew plenty of chances LW in a 2 pt home loss to the Chargers (missed GW 54 yd FG w/11 left). The Patriots have won each of the past 4 meetings against the Browns including a 45-7 (-2) blowout a year ago which saw them finish with 30-17 FD and 452-217 yard edges. With the Browns going just 3-7-1 ATS as a HF heading in, we give the Pats an excellent shot at picking up the outright upset no matter who lines up under center (rookie Zappe 17-21-188-1-1 in 1st career start vs DET).

GREEN BAY by 4 over NY Jets - The Packers return to Lambeau following a surprising 5 pt loss to the Giants as nearly DD chalk (led 20-10 at HT). The Jets meanwhile took advantage of matching up against MIA's 3rd string QB for most of LW's contest in an eventual 40-17 victory (NYJ 21 unanswered 4Q pts). After losing 3 straight from '00-'06, the Packers picked up 3 consecutive wins of their own against the Jets including a 44-38 OT road victory back in '18 (QB Aaron Rodgers 475 ttl yds & 4 ttl TD). While Packers are 10-3 ATS as home chalk and the Jets are just 2-7 ATS against NFC foes, we expect the visitor to stay within the line as they have already picked up a pair of surprising road upsets TY against the Browns (+6) and Steelers (+3).

Baltimore by 2 over NY GIANTS - Rematch of SB XXXV, a contest that saw the Ravens dominate the Giants by a 34-7 score. The Giants are back at home after a shocking 27-22 (+9) win in London against the Packers where they outscored GB 17-2 in the 2H. The Ravens meanwhile escaped LW at home against the Bengals with a GW 43-yd FG as time expired. In their most recent meeting back in '20, BAL (-10) picked up a 27-13 victory finishing with a 432-269 yd edge. The Giants have failed to cover 6 of their L/8 as a dog while also going just 4-10 ATS against the AFC. They are however a surprising 4-1 on the year and get a Ravens squad making their first of 3 road contests.

Minnesota at MIAMI - Following a 23 pt smackdown up North against the Jets where 3rd string QB Thompson (19-33-166-0-1) plyd all but the opening snaps for the concussed Tagovailoa and Bridgewater, the Dolphins welcome a MIN squad who picked up a 7 pt win LW against CHI (MIN 29-14 FD & 429-271 yd edges).
