KEY SELECTIONS

4★ LOUISVILLE over Duke - This game actually has huge ACC Title game implications. UL is 3-0 in this series with the last meeting in '21 when the Cards won 62-22 (-20). The Cards are fresh off a bye after a deflating 38-21 loss at Pitt where they had a 444-288 yd edge but were -3 TO's and gave up big plays including an 86 yd pick-6. The Cards D has held 3 straight foes under 300 yards. Riley Leonard surprisingly returned last week against FSU but only threw for 69 yds and left in the 3Q. The Blue Devils led 17-7 2Q after a pick-6 but allowed a KR td and only scored 3 points the rest of the way in a 38-20 (+14) loss. UL has the edge on offense, putting up 464 ypg while Duke is avg 371 and Leonard's status is clearly not 100%. UL is the fresher team and we like the Cardinals to get back to their winning ways under Jeff Brohm!

FORECAST: LOUISVILLE by 14

3★ OKLAHOMA ST over Cincinnati - 4th meeting, but have not met since 1983! Okla St is off a 48-34 win at WVU where RB Gordon ran for 282 yds (9.7, 4 td!) while Cincy had the yds edge vs Baylor LW but lost 32-29 (-1 TO, BU FR td). The Okla St offense is avg'g 467 ypg/36 ypg in B12 play and QB Bowman is finding a rhythm avg'g 266 pass ypg in B12 play & Cincy's pass D is giving up 276 ypg (62%) in conf play. Okla St's defense is allowing 442 ypg in B12 play and Cincy can run the ball (215, 5.0) and Okla St's run D can be hit or miss (155, 4.3). However, Okla St has the massive edge on offense (#24/#72) and Okla St is 9-2 ATS at home in B12 play since 2021 while Cincy is 0-3-1 ATS in B12 games this season & now must deal with a hostile night crowd in Stillwater for their homecoming game, gives us the Pokes here by nearly 3 td's!

FORECAST: OKLAHOMA ST by 20

3★ Troy over TEXAS ST - Both teams are coming off a bye and are both in the mix to win the SBC West division. However Troy is 8-0 SU/5-3 ATS against TXSt, but the past 2 meetings have been decided by 3 pts. TXSt's pass attack is led by QB Finley (69%, 14-3 ratio) but Troy has allowed just 6 td passes all season & TXSt's rush attack (209, 5.3) is facing a tough Troy run D allowing just 103 (3.1) on the season. Overall Troy's D is holding tms to 98 ypg under their avg (#8 FBS) and TXSt has taken on the #124 schedule and don't have a win over a team with a winning record TY. TXSt did allow 235 rush (5.2) vs SMiss and 218 rush (5.3) vs LA and now take on a Troy run game avg'g 225 (5.2) the L/4 gms led by RB Vidal (951, 6.2). Troy has the huge edge on D (#16 vs #122) and have failed to cover 3 of the L/4 gms while Troy has covered 3 straight. **FORECAST: TROY by 15**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ San Jose St over HAWAII - While SJSt has 3 straight wins over UH, they have failed to cover the L/2 mtgs as a favorite. SJSt picked up a 42-21 win last week over Utah ST despite the offense gaining under 400 yds as 3 of their TD drives were 40 yds or less. Hawaii is off a 42-21 loss at NMex where they were only outgained by 26 yds but were -4 TO's. SJSt QB Cordeiro is hitting 61% (11-3 ratio) but the offense is getting production from their run game (182, 5.8 in MW play) led by RB's Robinson (573, 6.1) and Conley (426, 7.0) & UH is giving up 230 (5.4) rush vs MW foes. UH doesn't have much of a run game (58, 2.5) but are passing for 306 ypg, however SJSt is allowing just 183 pass ypg and will key in on stopping the pass since UH can't run the ball. SJSt beat NMex by 28 pts 2 wks ago & UH just lost by 21 LW. SJSt still has hopes of a bowl game and are riding a 2 gm win streak & we'll call for the Spartans to extend that streak with another big win here. **FORECAST: San Jose St by 14**

2★ Tennessee over KENTUCKY - This is a series dominated by the Vols who have won 18 of the last 20 played in Lexington and are 24-7 ATS in this series since 1992. Last year KY was no match for the Vols who finished with a 422-205 yd edge and won 44-6 (-11). Tenn led Bama 20-7 at half but was shutout in the 2H and lost the cover on a 24 yd fumble return td. Tenn finished with a 404-358 yd edge. KY is fresh off a bye after a misleading loss to Mizou. They led 14-0 1Q and 21-20 3Q but lost by 17. KY has been held under 300 yds in their last 2 games. The Vols D is allowing just 311 ypg and is keeping foes 83 ypg below their avg (#16 in FBS). Tenn has the edge in all 3 phases, has played a tougher schedule (#21 vs #76) and owns the series. They are only laying 3 points so this is an easy call. **FORECAST: Tennessee by 10**

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 25th

Jacksonville St by 6 over FIU - JSU actually won the only prior meeting in '20 as a 10' pt away dog. These two coaches are familiar with each other from their time in the PAC-12 where Rich Rod went 5-1 SU. Once again JSU trailed by double-digits last week but beat WKU 20-17 (+7). The Gamecocks have actually trailed by double digits at one point in each of their last four games. FIU is 4-4 SU/ATS this season and this is a critical game for the Panthers to get bowl eligible. Last week they pulled out an OT win over Sam Houston 33-27 (+5). JSU is coming off possibly the biggest win in school history, beating the pre-season CUSA favorite and now they are laying 8 pts on the road at a well coached FIU team so we will take the points.

Uteq by 2 over SAM HOUSTON - UTEP won both previous meetings but these two CUSA foes haven't met since '03. The Miners will need to win out to reach a bowl and can get started against a SH team that hasn't figured out how to finish games yet. UTEP won on the road two weeks ago at FIU 27-14. That same FIU team went on the road and beat SH last week 33-27 in OT. The Bearkats are 0-7 SU/3-4 ATS with three close losses in CUSA play. After putting up just 10 pts and 443 yds in their F/3 games they've has averaged 385 ypg in the last 4. QB Shoemaker has an 8-3 ratio in their last 4. UTEP is +15 ypg while SH is -23 ypg in CUSA play so we are taking UTEP to win a close game but the early line has us leaning with the underdog Bearkats.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 26th

VIRGINIA TECH by 6 over Syracuse - Cuse pulled upsets in the last two meetings in '16 & '21. VT was leading by 9 and let Cuse score 2 td's in the last 2:28 to win the last meeting. Both tms are fresh off a bye. The Hokies have won their last two home games by 17 pts each, beating Pitt (+2) & Wake Forest (-1). QB Kyron Drones has sparked the offense with a 6-1 ratio and he's a tough runner at 230 lbs (344, 3.8). Cuse started the season 4-0, beating 3 weak foes but have since lost 3 straight to the ACC's top 3 teams. Their losses were by 17, 37 & 38 and they were -267 ypg in those. VT is 14-6 SU at home in Thursday Night games since 1994 and this should be a loud crowd so we expect the Hokies to give their fans plenty to cheer about.

GEORGIA SOUTHERN by 3 over Georgia St - GSt has won and covered the last 3 meetings and in LY's meeting GSt had a 522-451 yd edge and picked off GStHrn 4 times in a 41-33 win. GSt comes in with the #112 pass D as they are allowing 275 ypg (65%) and GStHrn is throwing for 319 ypg (67%). GSt's offense is running for 177 ypg (4.5) but the GStHrn run D is giving up just 122 ypg (3.9) and the Eagles pass D has all'd just 8 td's and have 9 int's. Overall GStHrn has the edge in offense (#45 vs #91) and ST's (#70 vs #94). GStHrn was at home last week and are at home here, while GSt was on the road last week, now must travel again on a short week. We'll take the Eagles to win a close rivalry game.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 27th

Florida Atlantic by 9 over CHARLOTTE - These teams met the last 8 yrs as members of CUSA, but this is their 1st meeting in the AAC. FAU has won the L/4 in the series (3-1 ATS) and has won all 4 meetings in CLT. FAU had won 2 straight going into last week but couldn't match up with UTSA in a 36-10 (+2) win where they were outgained 437-162. CLT's defense has allowed just 392 yards

in their last 2 games including their 10-7 (+6) road upset over ECU last week. FAU looked great the two weeks prior to the loss and they've only truly played bad twice this year. All five of CLT's losses are by double-digits and they are on a 1-9 ATS run at home. FAU has clear edges in all 3 phases and are laying less than a td, so we'll fly with the Owls in this one.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 28th

MINNESOTA by 10 over Michigan St - MSU has won 5 of the L/6 vs the Gophers but Min is 5-1 ATS in those gms and dominated the Spartans LY as they outgained MSU 508-240 in their 34-7 (+3) road win. Minn pulled out a 12-10 win over Iowa last week thanks and had a 239-127 yd edge but were fortunate to not give up a PR td late that was overturned but a controversial ruling (Cost us our top LPSI). Mich St was ambushed at home by rival Michigan 49-0 (+24). The Spartans were outgained 477-190 and are in the midst of a 5 game losing streak. The home team is just 1-5 ATS in this series but we have no faith in this Michigan St team and Minn still has aspirations of winning the Big 10 West so we will take the Gophers by double-digits.

ARMY by 16 over Massachusetts - 4h mtg s/19, Army has been a 20+ fav in L/3, going 3-0 SU (by 36 ppg) & 2-1 ATS (failed to cover 36 pt HF in '21). LY Army (-20) won 44-7 putting up 329 yds rush, UMass is off a bye, giving them an extra week to prepare for Army's Off. Still both teams last game were lopsided shutout losses. UMass lost 63-0 to then #6 Penn St as a 4' pt AD (outgained 408-109). LW Army lost 62-0 at #19 LSU as a 32' pt AD (outgained 570-193). With their starting QB out, Army's true frosh QB Champ Harris made his first career start (4-9-22, -9 rush) & true frosh QB Larry Robinson (2-6-20, 17 rush) played most of 2H, UMass is allowing 223 ypg rush & 6.0 YPC! That has us calling for Army to take care of business here.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 17 over Connecticut - BC is out for legit revenge after losing at UConn 13-3 last year. Jeff Hafley was on the hot seat after a 1-3 start but they've won 3 straight and this game puts them in great shape for bowl eligibility. Last week BC was +5 at GTech. They trailed 23-17 4Q but had 72, 72 & 60 yd td drives and won 38-23. UConn is just 1-6 SU/3-4 ATS. They led USF 21-10 (+1) last week but allowed 75 & 90 yd td drives, losing by a fg. That was their 4th loss by 7 points or less and they also only lost to NCSt by 10 in the opener. However, BC has gotten on a roll and with revenge in mind they won't overlook this team as the Eagles have a legit shot to reach 9-3. BC is +37 ypg against our #46 sked while UConn is -70 ypg against our #84 sked and the Eagles are laying less than 2 td's.

Florida St by 17 over WAKE FOREST - WF has actually won the last 3 in this series including last year 31-21 (-6). Going back to last year, FSU has won their last 13 games, the 2nd longest active winning streak in the FBS. We picked up a 3★ LPS and Newsletter winner on FSU last week when they rallied to beat Duke 38-20. We were also robbed of a 4H LPS winner going against Wake Forest. The Deacons were playing with a 3rd string QB, and were on the verge of losing but Pitt's QB slid just short of a first down which would have ended the game. WF scored the GW td with just :07 left. Prior to that drive WF only had 275 yds. The 'Noles have played the tougher schedule (#5 vs #75) and they have a huge edge on offense (#6 vs #93) but WF is 17-7-1 ATS vs ranked foes and only lost by 5 at Clemson. FSU is clearly the better team but the situation greatly favors WF so we are putting this right at the opening line.

MIAMI, FL by 13 over Virginia - Both teams come off huge upset wins here. UVA started the season 0-5 but have won two straight and have been more competitive than their record indicates. Last week they were +23' but upset North Carolina 23-17, ending an 8 game losing streak vs FBS foes. UM was playing w/o QB Van Dyke against Clemson last week. Emory Williams threw for 151 yds in his first career start and the 'Canes won 28-20 (+4). UM is 2-8 as an ACC home favorite and they are off two straight big games against NC and Clemson. UVA has covered the last 4 games this year and are 3-0 ATS in this series. There was nothing lucky about UVA's win last week and the situation greatly favors the underdog so we think the Cavaliers keep it closer than expected.

UCF by 3 over West Virginia - First meeting. UCF is off a close loss at OU where they missed a late 2-pt try to tie the game. WVU is off a 14-pt loss to Okla St where they allowed 491 td yds. WVU looks to run the ball with RB Donaldson & QB Greene, and they should have success here vs a UCF run D allowing 256 (5.7) vs Big 12 foes & overall are -68 ypg/-11 ppg in the Big 12. While UCF does have an explosive run game of their own (232, 5.6) WVU's run D is allowing just 119 ypg (3.6) and WVU's pass D ranks #28, however they did allow 281 rush yds (8.5) last week. UCF is favored here by a td and we like them to get their first Big 12 win, but WVU has played the tougher sked (#29 vs #40) and already pulled off a road upset at TCU a few weeks back so they aren't intimidated by tough road environments and will keep this close.

Arkansas St by 1 over ULM - This is a series dominated by Ark St as they have won and covered the past 13 meetings against ULM! Ark St played CC close LW, losing just 27-17 (-14 yds) and ULM played GStHrn close and actually had the yds edge! Ark St's is now led by QB Raynor, who is hitting 61% (12-3) and his best game came against UMass (20-25, 383, 6 tds) who has the #131 pass D and now he faces a ULM pass D ranked #111 that has all'd 297 ypg (62%) the L/4 gms. While Ark St's D is allowing foes to gain 65 ypg above their avg (#127 FBS) ULM is only putting up 359 ypg in SBC play. This is only the 3rd time during this win streak that Ark St is an underdog, but we'll call for Ark St to get the outright win & they are 6-3 ATS as an away dog the L2Y.

North Carolina by 18 over GEORGIA TECH - NC is out for double-revenge here after losing by 4 last year as a 21 pt favorite and LTH lost 45-22 as 13' pt home chalk. The Heels were 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS entering last week but were upset 31-27 vs 23' pt home favorites. They are still +130 ypg but their two worst performances were as double-digit favorites which they are here. GT led BC 23-17 to start the 4Q but in the 4Q they allowed 72, 72 & 60 yd td drives while turning it over twice themselves for a 38-23 (-5) loss. The Jackets run D is ranked last in the ACC, allowing 228 (5.3) and last week they gave up 308 (7.2). NC's Omarion Hampton leads the ACC with 770 (5.9) rushing. Mack Brown has now suffered 4 upset losses as double-digit favorites but they've covered the following week twice when installed as a double-digit favorite again and we like the revenge minded Heels in a bounce back effort.

Clemson by 6 over NC STATE - Clemson is 16-2 SU but only 9-9 ATS in this series and NCSt has covered 4 of the L/6 when hosting. NCSt is fresh off a bye and the week prior Duke held them to 3 points thanks to a litany of dropped passes and penalties. NCSt actually had the yardage and FD edge. Clemson caught Miami without their starting QB last week and led 17-7 4Q but lost in OT 28-20. The Tigers once again had a fumble on the goal line and were -2 TO's. NCSt has a solid D, holding foes 23 ypg below their avg. Clemson is also holding foes 90 ypg below their avg. It's hard to believe the Tigers now have 3 conference losses. NCSt has covered 4 of their last 5 as home dogs including an outright upset over Clemson in '20. This has all the makings of a low scoring defensive affair so we will lean with the dog.

APPALACHIAN ST by 24 over Southern Miss - First meeting here. Last met in 2014 where App St (+1) lost 21-20 despite being +126 yds & +13 FD's. SMiss's season has gotten away from them, as they sit at 1-6 SU/ATS on the ssn & are off an embarrassing effort vs SAAla where they trailed 31-0 HT (outgained 402-26) and lost 55-3 (outgained 647-149!). App St is off an upset loss at ODU where they scored the GW td with 48 sec left 4Q. SMiss is -111 ypg/-19 ppg vs SBC foes and they are facing an App St offense avg'g 444 ypg/29 ppg vs SBC foes & are passing for 297 ypg in conf gms & SMiss just gave up 360 pass yds to SAAla last week. With SMiss looking like they have thrown in the towel, we'll take App St by over 3 td's.

Marshall by 3 over COASTAL CAROLINA - Only prior meeting came LY where CC led 21-10 HT (205-173) and won 24-13 despite getting held to 66 total yds 2H (-136 yds for the game). MU is off a game where RB Ali and 5 other str's didn't play and the offense put up 169 total yds & all'd 8 sks and were held scoreless in a 20-9 loss to JMU (MU scored on KR td & safety). CC 27-17 at Ark St LW (3★ PS winner!) and CC's offense is up to avg'g 468 ypg in SBC play while the typically strong MU defense is allowing 438 ypg in SBC play and overall are allowing foes to gain 29 ypg above their avg (#105 FBS) & their run D is allowing 212 ypg (6.1) the L/4 gms while CC is avg'g 183 rush ypg (4.8). MU's offense is led by RB Ali (CS) but CC could be without QB McCall after he took a hit to the head last week & would start QB Guest. With questions to key players on both teams we'll call for this one at the line.

JAMES MADISON by 24 over Old Dominion - 4th meeting. LY JMU (-7) led 17-3 at the half and overall had a 492-227 yd edge in a 37-3 win. JMU is off a 20-9 win over Marshall where they held them to -4 rush yds (169 tt yds) and did not allow an offensive score (KR td & safety). Overall JMU is holding teams to 77 ypg under their avg (#17 FBS) and their run D is holding tms to 36 ypg (1.2)! ODU is putting up 392 ypg vs SBC foes, but their OLine has allowed 37 sacks (21.5%!&) & JMU has collected 34 sacks incl 8 last week & DE Green leads the FBS w/ 13 sks. JMU has big edges in offense (#54/#112), defense (#18/#92) and ST's (#14/#120). While ODU has covered 5 straight as a dog, JMU has covered 5 straight games and are rolling through the SBC and we expect them to roll once again here in front of their home fans.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Western Michigan - EM has won 4 straight vs WM, all 4 being outright upsets, LY Eagles (+6) led 21-0 2Q & 35-7 HT cruising to a 45-23 win finishing with a 413-299 yd edge. WM is just 2-6 SU incl 1-3 in MAC play but have covered 4 of L/5 & all 3 MAC losses were to Division leaders (UT, Miami & Ohio). LW they only lost 20-17 to Ohio as a 16' pt AD but never led & were outgained 460-369. EM is 4-4 SU incl 2-2 in MAC play & has covered 4 straight. LW EM (+12) led NIU 13-10 into 4Q but allowed a GW td w/1:11 left & were int'd from the NIU 42 4 plays later. Western has the better offense (#84-#132) but EM has the better defense (#81-#117) with WM being last in the MAC in scoring Def (34.3 ppg) & Total defense (405 ypg). EM also has a HUGE ST's edge (#3 vs #133). WM has opened as a small favorite, which has us happily taking EM & the pts as the Eagles are on a 26-6-1 ATS run as a MAC Dog!

OHIO by 3 over Miami, Oh - Battle of the Bricks. Both teams come in 6-1 & 3-1 in MAC play ties for #1 in MAC East along with Buffalo. Underdog has 3 outright wins the L/4 mtg but LY Ohio (-2) despite only leading 17-14 3Q pulled away for a 37-21 win. LW Ohio despite a 460-369 yd edge struggled to get by WM 20-17 as a 16' pt HF. Miami despite having starting QB Gabbert, who was leading the MAC in passing yds, carted off with a ssn ending injury, was driving for GW td, when backup QB Smith fumbled & they lost to Toledo 21-17 as a 2 pt HD. Backup QB Smith is a dual-threat QB who started 9 gms LY going 5-4 as the starter. Both went 2-0 SU vs KS & WM, with Miami (2-0 ATS) winning by an avg 17 ppg with a 49 ypg edge while Ohio was 1-1 ATS winning by 14 ypg with a 26 ypg edge. While we look for Ohio to win, Miami should keep it close.

Oklahoma by 17 over KANSAS - OU has won 18 straight games SU against KU and more recently have covered 6 of the L/9 gms. OU's offense is putting up 497 ypg/43 ppg led by QB Gabriel (71%, 19-3) and recently KU's defense has struggled against better offenses, as they allowed 661 yds vs Texas & 554 yds vs Okla St. KU also has the #89 pass D, allowing 297 ypg (65%) the L/4 gms and their run D has given up 252 ypg (5.9) the L/3 gms. KU does avg 212 rush ypg (5.6) but the OU run D is allowing just 119 (3.4). Overall OU's D has shown improvement TY, holding tms to 66 ypg under their avg & they have the big edge on D (#31 vs #91). OU is 5-1-1 ATS TY & off a close call the Sooners will be re-focused and we like them here by over 2 td's.

PENN ST by 31 over Indiana - PSU has won 20 of 22 in the series, including 10 straight in Happy Valley. IU has covered 3 of the last 5 but lost 24-0 (+12) LTH in '21. PSU struggled to get their offense moving last week at Ohio St in a 20-12 (+4) loss where they put up just 240 yds. QB Allar still has a 13-0 ratio but they've connected on the least explosive plays (20 yds or more) in the country. They are still allowing just 218 ypg and holding foes 115 ypg below their avg (#2 in FBS) but lost DE Chop Robinson (4 sks TY) to a leg injury. Indiana switched back to their opening day starter Brendan Sorsby in their 17 pt loss to Rutgers last week. James Franklin is just 1-5 as Big 10 20+ chalk and 10-23 ATS off a SU loss and while they did cover off their last 2 losses to OSU, those lines were in the low teens while this week they are laying over 4 td's.

NEBRASKA by 7 over Purdue - Purdue has won and covered the L/2 vs Neb, including a 28-23 (+7) upset win LTH in '21. Neb is off a 17-9 (-10) win over Northwestern which puts them at 4-3 and a great shot to get bowl eligible. Purdue is just 2-5 SU/ATS but are fresh off a bye. The Boilermakers are -25 ypg but they have taken on our #3 schedule while Neb is +15 ypg taking on our #36 sked. The underdog is 9-1 ATS in this series with 6 outright upsets and Purdue is 22-6 as an away dog but the Huskers are only laying a fg here and we love the defensive edge for the Huskers who are holding foes 59 ypg below their avg. We will take the home team to win by a touchdown.

Maryland by 9 over NORTHWESTERN - NW has won 2 of 3 vs MD and has covered all 3, including a 31-24 (+14.5) loss at MD last year that was tied late into the 4th before the Terps scored the winning td with 3:22 left. NW covered last week as 10' pt away dogs, losing 17-9 at Nebraska. The Wildcats held the Huskers to a ssn low 248 yards. Maryland is off a bye, but the week prior they lost to IL 27-24 (-13') and MD is just 3-9 SU (2-10 ATS) vs B10 West foes under Locksley so we'll take the Wildcats at home getting around 2 tds.

Air Force by 10 over COLORADO ST - Air Force has won 6 straight gms against CSU but the home team has failed to cover the L/6 mtgs. AF QB Larrier was reported out LW but started vs Navy and AF won 17-6 but AF was held to a ssn-low 137 rush yds. We expect AF's rush attack to get back on track this week vs a CSU run D that has struggled of late (211, 4.4 the L/4 gms) and now face the #1 rush attack in the FBS (306, 5.3). CSU's offense is led by their pass attack (336 ypg) but QB Fowler-Nicolosi has thrown 11 int's in 6 starts and AF's pass D has allowed just 154 pass ypg (60%). While AF will not overlook a conf game and a chance to get to 8-0 for the first time since 1985, they are in a unique situation of being off Navy and having Army on deck and are laying DD's.

BOISE ST by 3 over Wyoming - While WY is only 1-7 SU vs Boise in their L/8, they have covered 7 of the 8 mtgs. Both teams enter off a bye and both are still in the mix for the MW title gm. WY RB Waylee missed their last gm, but off a bye should be back in the lineup as he has 540 rush yds (7.2) in just 4 gms. Boise QB's Green & Madsen are still splitting reps & their offense is led by RB Ashton Jeanty (868, 5.7, 11 td). Boise's D has been an issue this ssn, as they are all'g foes to gain 45 ypg above their avg (#116 FBS). The only major concern on WY is that their run D has allowed 206 ypg (5.0) over the L/4 gms and now face one of the top RB's in the FBS in Jeanty, but with a week to prep WY HC Bohl will have his team ready to go & will battle Boise close.

Oregon by 3 over UTAH - After rebounding nicely LW against the Cougars (RB Irving 129 rush yds & 2 TD) following their 1st loss of the ssn the week prior against the Huskies, the Ducks head to SLC to take on a Utes squad that escaped with a 34-32 victory (+7) win at USC (GW 38-yd FG w/0:00 left, Utah 23-18 FD & 482-401 yd edges). The home team in this series is on a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS run including LY where the Ducks (+2) pulled out a 20-17 victory in Eugene (led 17-3 at HT). With the previous home success along with the dog covering 5 of the L/8 including 5 outright upsets, we're banking on the Utes to stay within the line in this one.

FRESNO ST by 4 over UNLV - Fresno has won 5 straight vs UNLV, but the Rebels have covered the L/2 gms as both of those gms were decided by 8 pts and 7 pts. UNLV is off a 25-23 win vs CSU where K Pizano hit 6 fg's incl the GW kick with 3 sec left. Fresno's D is allowing just 330 ypg/20 ppg but in their last gm vs Utah St they allowed 568 yds & 32 pts and they face a UNLV offense avg'g 488 yds the L/4 gms led by their strong rush attack (233, 5.0 vs MW foes) & QB Maiava threw for 353 (75%) LW. Fresno should get QB Keene back (missed last gm) and could have success vs UNLV's #72 pass D as the Rebels are good vs the run (130, 3.8). Neither team has a win over a foe with a winning record, yet Fresno is over a td favorite and we have been impressed with the Rebels this season & think they keep this game close.

Use by 8 over CALIFORNIA - Following a 2nd consecutive loss LW against the Utes who finished with a 482-401 yd edge and hit a GW 38-yd FG as time expired, USC heads North to take on a Cal squad that's fresh off a bye. Prior to their week off Cal (+9) was held to a ssn-low 254 yds in a 34-14 loss at Utah. The Trojans have won 16 of the last 18 in this series (11-7 ATS) including LY in LA where they escaped with a 41-35 victory (-21) thanks in part to 398 tt yds and 5 TD's from QB Caleb Williams. With the Bears going 11-5 ATS overall as a HD under HC Wilcox and USC failing to cover each of their road matchups TY including a blowout loss in South Bend 2 weeks ago, we'll call for Cal to keep this one closer than expected (USC has a home meeting with Wash on deck!).

Washington St by 3 over ARIZONA ST - After an outstanding 4-0 start to the ssn where they averaged 44 ypg and 534 ypg, the Cougs have fallen on hard times since returning from their bye with an 0-3 SU (1-2 ATS) mark including a 14 pt defeat LW in Eugene against the Ducks (WSU QB Ward 468 tt yds & 1 TD). WSU now heads into the desert to take on a Sun Devils squad that's covered each of their 4 contests inside of the P12 including a 15-7 defeat (+27) a week ago in Seattle where they led in the 4Q before allowing a crucial 90-yd IR TD (ASU 20-17 FD & 341-288 yd edges). In their Pullman meeting a year ago, the Cougars (-9) jumped out to a 28-0 HT lead before allowing 18 unanswered points in the 2H for a closer than expected 10 pt victory. While WSU has gone an impressive 15-6-1 ATS inside of the P12, we like ASU to stay within the spread as the home team is 9-1 ATS in this series.

UCLA by 13 over Colorado - The Buffs picked the wrong time to blow a 29-0 HT lead as the comeback win by the Cardinal 2 weeks ago likely gave Colorado a bad taste in their mouth for the entire bye week. They now head into Pasadena to take on a Bruins squad that picked up a 42-7 pt victory against that same Stanford team a week ago with QB Garbers regaining his starting role (Wk 1 starter) and putting up 291 yds of tt offense with 2 TD's. In their P12 meetings the dog has won just once in 12 tries (6-6 ATS). LY's meeting in Boulder saw UCLA (-21) finish with a 515-309 yd edge in the 45-17 victory. With the Bruins covering just 7 of their last 20 as home chalk and the past 3 conf games for the Buffs being decided by 7, 3 and 3, expect the visitor to stay within the line in this one.

Over 41 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 61% winners over 41 years!! **Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years including the last two weeks with Oklahoma St and BYU winning outright!**. Here is This week's Underdog Play:

RICE +11' over Tulane

RICE (+) over Tulane - 1st meeting since 2013. Rice is off an impressive 42-10 (+3) road win over Tulsa in which they never trailed and outgained the Hurricane 512-294. QB JT Daniels threw for 342 & 2 tds and is now hitting 64% with a 17-5 ratio. The Owls defense held Tulsa to 105 yds below their season avg. Tulane jumped out to a 21-0 lead over North Texas last week but needed a late td to win 35-28 (-20). They've now won 5 straight but their last 3 all came within 2 td's. Tulane is only #74 in our pass D rankings (263 ypg, 67%, 9-9) and Daniels has a 17-5 ratio. Rice's largest loss aside from Texas is by just 13 points which leads us to think they stay within the line. We wouldn't be shocked if Rice pulled the outright upset so they get the call as our underdog POW!

Oregon St by 1 over ARIZONA - The Wildcats return from their bye week having covered 3 straight contests including a surprising 44-6 (+7) upset in Pullman against the Cougars where they finished with a 516-234 yd edge (+3 TO's). Ironically, the Beavers have also covered 3 in a row as they return from their own week off. Their most recent victory came at home against UCLA where we picked up a Top Play 4★ LP Winner in a game that they led by 19 heading into the 4Q! In their most recent meeting back in '19, the Beavers (+5) went into Tucson and picked up a 56-38 upset win in a game that featured over 1,000 total yards of combined offense! While we expect the defense to play better this time around, also keep in mind that OSU is a much different team on the road (3-6 ATS as AF under HC Smith) compared to their dominant record in Corvallis. With Arizona outgaining their P12 foes by a 428-357 yd clip on the year, we expect them to stay inside of a FG in this one.

New Mexico by 3 over NEVADA - Nev is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS since 2011 against NMex, but have not played since 2020 where Nev (-17) only won by 7 pts and were just +40 yds. NMex is off a 42-21 win against Haw where they were just +26 yds but were +4 TO's and we won a 3★ LP on the Over 60. Nev finally broke their losing streak last week as they won 6-0 at SDSt as they put up just 242 yds but held SDSt to 204 yds. Before LW Nev's D was allowing 512 ypg and take on a NMex offense that is avg'g 412 ypg/31 ppg in MW play and are running for 190 (5.5) vs MW foes, while Nev's run D is allowing 192 (5.5) for the ssn. NMex still has a chance at a bowl and are improved this season and we'll call for the team with more to play for to win by a FG.

Washington by 24 over STANFORD - Following a closer than expected 15-7 home win LW against the Sun Devils (key 89-yd IR TD in 4Q to take lead, UW outgained 341-288, -3 TO's) to remain unbeaten for the ssn, the Huskies head into Palo Alto to take on a Cardinal squad that suffered a 35 pt defeat LW at home against UCLA with the Bruins finishing with dominating 32-15 FD and 503-292 yd edges. UW has won and covered the past 2 years against Stanford including a 20-13 (+2) upset on "The Farm" 2 years ago where they got a GW 20 yd TD pass with :21 left (Huskies 375-265 yd edge). With the home team on a 9-3 SU (8-4 ATS) run in this series and the Huskies having a huge road trip to USC on deck, we wouldn't be surprised to see Stanford stay within the hefty spread.

Georgia by 11 over Florida - UGA has won 5 of the last 6 meetings including last year when the Dawgs jumped out to a 28-3 lead at half (346-89 yds) but UF did get within 8 in the 3Q before UGA added 2 td's. The last nine meetings in this rivalry have been decided by 20.2 ppg. UGA's offense will look much different w/o Mackey winning TE Brock Bowers who was inj'd in their win over Vandy prior to their bye. Fans were ready to give up on Billy Napier when they were down 37-27 late 4Q vs South Carolina but they had two 75 yd td drives and won 41-39 (+1). The Gators are now 5-2 and are +54 ypg vs FBS foes on the season. UGA has only played one complete game all season when the blew out KY but they had slow starts in their first four games including against South Carolina when they trailed 14-3 at half and also only beat Auburn by 7 on the road. With the Bulldogs missing their best player, and UF an underrated team we think this ends closer than expected.

NOTRE DAME by 22 over Pittsburgh - These two meet for the first time since '20 when this was actually a conference game and ND won 45-3 (-10). The Irish are fresh off a much needed bye after playing four straight undefeated ranked teams. Pitt needed one first down to beat Wake Forest last week but QB Veilleux slid before reaching the marker which ultimately lost us a 3★ LPS. The Panthers did put up their most yards (414) vs an FBS foe this season. ND owned ACC foes prior to their loss to Louisville, and are still 29-1 SU/21-9 ATS in those games. They should easily win here and we are surprised this line opened with the Irish only being -17. QB Veilleux will face his toughest test yet against ND who has our #2 pass D (153 ypg, 52%, 5-9). Pitt has been a solid away dog (16-11 ATS) but they already lost by 17 at VTech this year and at 2-5 with FSU on deck a bowl seems very unlikely so we are going with the Irish by over 3 td's.

Memphis by 3 over NORTH TEXAS - These teams met in Memphis LY as non-conf foes and now meet in the AAC for the 1st time. Mem led 41-20 but only won 44-34 (-12.5), giving up a back-door cover with 2:31 left. Ever since switching to ULM transfer QB Rogers, NT has been a much better team. The Mean Green has won 3 of their last five with two close losses including last week where they only fell 35-28 (+20) at Tulane. QB Rogers now has a 14-1 ratio and they are +85 ypg in the 5 games he's started. Memphis was tied with UAB at half 21-21 last week but ran away in the 2H for a 24 pt win (-7). The Tigers were outgained 381-352 but were +4 TO's. The Tigers are just 4-10 ATS on the road under Silverfield and this is only their 2nd true road game this season. NT has been on a tear offensively, so give us the Mean Green getting a td at home.

Iowa St by 3 over BAYLOR - Baylor has covered 5 straight vs ISU, but all of those were as an underdog, and they are a slight favorite here. ISU comes in fresh off a bye week, while BU was at Cincy LW and won 32-29 and QB Shapen threw for 316 yards after throwing for 324 the week prior vs TTech. Shapen won't have the same success against ISU pass D ranked #4 as they have 12 int's on the ssn. Overall ISU's D is holding foes to 61 ypg under their avg (#24 FBS). BU's defense has had issues this ssn & are allowing 447 ypg/35 ppg vs B12 foes and ISU's offense is showing life in B12 play (373 ypg/28 ppg) and QB Becht is hitting 60% (12-5 ratio). ISU's OL has also allowed just 4 sks in 214 pass att (1.9%). ISU has covered 3 of their 4 B12 games this ssn & we'll take the Cyclones by a fg and ISU is a slight favorite as of presstime.

KANSAS ST by 23 over Houston - First meeting. UH is off a 31-24 close loss against Texas where they were +32 yds, but -2 TO's. KSt is off a blowout win 41-3 at home vs TCU where they had a and we won a 3★ LP play on the Under 60! KSt played both QB's Howard & Johnson LW and will do so here as they combined for 244 pass yds & 135 rush yds LW and overall KSt's run game is avg'g 279 ypg (6.3) against B12 foes and UH's run D is giving up 196 (4.6) against B12 tms TY. UH is -83 ypg/-12 ppg in conf play while KSt is +83 ypg/+15 ppg & against common foes TCU & Tex Tech UH is -451 yds/-44 pts while KSt is +242 yds/+55 pts. KSt does have Texas on deck, but are now on an 8-1 ATS run as a Big 12 HF under Klieman & we like them by over 3 td's.

Ohio St by 7 over WISCONSIN - OSU has won 9 straight (7-2 ATS) vs the Badgers, including a 52-21 (-19) beatdown in Columbus last year in which they outgained UW 539-296. Braedyn Locke had his first career start and threw for 240 yards and 2 td's at Illinois. He also led the two 4Q td drives of 82 & 83 yds in the Badgers come-from-behind win 25-21 (-3). OSU held PSU to a ssn low 240

yards and they are giving up just 260 ypg on the season. The Buckeyes also put up the most yds that PSU has allowed with 365. This will be a lively crowd in Camp Randall and the Buckeyes are 0-3 ATS off their last 3 wins over Penn St including last year when they only beat NW 21-7 as 38 pt chalk so we have a slight lean on the home team.

TEXAS by 27 over BYU - BYU has won 4 of the 5 mtgs all-time. Last met in '14 in Austin where BYU blew out Texas 41-7 (+171 yds). BYU is off a 27-14 win against TT where they were outgained by 112 yds but were +5 TO's incl a fumble return for td & we picked up an outright winner on the Underdog POW and a 4★ LP play on BYU! Texas only won by 7 pts LW at Houston & were outgained in that game. However, BYU's offense is still struggling as they are avg'g just 295 yds in B12 play and are -160 ypg in conf play while Texas is +137 ypg. However Texas lost QB Ewers to a shoulder inj LW and he will miss this game, so bkp QB Murphy will be the guy and has plenty of talent, so we don't expect a big drop off. Texas will likely rely more on their run game (179, 4.7) led by RB Brooks (824, 6.5) and BYU is allowing 188 rush ypg (4.9) vs B12 foes. BYU struggled at TCU 2 wks ago and we think they will struggle in the state of Texas again.

AUBURN by 9 over Mississippi St - MSU has won the last two over Auburn but hasn't won 3 straight in this series since '97-'00. Auburn was tied at half vs Ole Miss but lost 28-21 (+6) and were outgained 425-275. MSU's offense was equally bad last week, playing w/o QB Rogers putting up just 7 points and 205 yards yet they upset Arkansas 7-3 (+6). The Bulldogs are actually 4-3 and have a great shot at a bowl while Auburn is 3-4 but also has a shot at a bowl with a week closing schedule. Auburn's four losses have come against the top of the SEC and they should win at home laying under a td.

OLE MISS by 28 over Vanderbilt - Ole Miss has won 4 straight in this series by 24 ppg, covering 3 of the 4. Vandy is fresh off a bye and did play UGA tougher than expected the week prior, only losing 37-20 (+32) for their first cover of the season, though the 'Dores were outgained 552-219 in that game. Ole Miss is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS after beating Auburn 28-21 (-6) with a 425-275 yd edge last week. The Rebels are +108 ypg while Vandy is -88 ypg. After a slow start, RB Judkins has topped 100 in two of his last 3 and Vandy is allowing 201 (6.0) rush ypg in SEC play. Vandy is actually 8-5 as an SEC away dog but are 2-8 ATS vs ranked teams. Ole Miss has A&M on deck but we think the Rebels still pull away by 4 td's.

TEXAS A&M by 21 over South Carolina - A&M is out for revenge after handing SC a 17-0 lead just over 5 minutes in last year. The Aggies got within 3 in the 4Q but lost 30-24. A&M is fresh off a bye. They have a huge defensive edge here (#6 vs #83) and held Spencer Rattler to just 168 yds, 0 td's and less than 50% completions on the road last year. SC was down 24-0 last week at Mizzou and lost 34-12. They finished with a season low 286 yards and now face a defense allowing just 278 ypg (#2 in SEC). A&M also is tied for #1 in the SEC with 29 sacks while SC is tied for #2 in sacks allowed with 31. Two years ago we used A&M as our October 5★ and they made it easy on us, leading 31-0 at half with a 268-11 yd edge and won by 30 (-19). We could see a similar result here with the Aggies angry after two close losses to Bama and Tennessee so this is absolutely in the mix for our GOM!

SOUTH ALABAMA by 13 over Louisiana - LY's 20-17 win vs LA snapped a 6 game losing streak by the Jags in this series. SA comes into this game with a few extra days rest after beating SMiss 55-3 last Tues where they were +498 yds & +22 FD's! LA was outgained by 54 yds LW against GSSt as they put up just 289 yds in a 20-17 loss. LA's pass D ranks #122 and are facing a SAAla pass attack that has put up 387 yds & 360 yds the past 2 gms. SAAla is also running the ball well of late, putting up 202 yds & 287 yds the L/2 gms. SAAla's D is also allowing just 259 ypg in SBC play while LA's offense is only avg'g 354 ypg the L/3 gms. SAAla has a big edge in offense (#22 vs #88) and defense (#22 vs #96) plus LA has played just the #123 sked. Despite SAAla having Troy on deck, they finally look to be hitting their stride & we'll call for the Jags by just under 2 td's.

SMU by 24 over Tulsa - Teams have met every yr '14 and SMU is 6-3 SU/ATS in the series, but Tulsa has covered 4 straight in Dallas. Tulsa had a modest 2 gm win streak heading in to their matchup with Rice last Thursday, but the Hurricane never led in their 42-10 (-3) home loss. Tulsa rotated QB's but both fumbled and starter Braxton also threw an int. The Hurricane defense were gashed on the ground & the air as they allowed 512 ttl yds after allowing 328 ypg the previous 3 wks. SMU crushed Tulsa 55-0 on Friday night, finishing with a 563-131 yd edge. All five of their wins are by 18 points or more and we see no reason to think they won't do something similar here.

UTSA by 14 over East Carolina - 1st meeting. UTSA has turned things up since entering conference play, starting 3-0 with all 3 wins by at least 16 points. Last week they beat FAU on the road 36-10 (-2) and finished w/a 437-162 yd edge. The Roadrunners are +75 ypg in AAC play though they were outgained by both Ttech and UAB. EC is -44 in CUSA play and just lost to Charlotte 10-7, getting held to a ssn low 127 yds. The Pirates are 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS on the season. ECU HC Houston is 9-2 ATS as a DD dog in AAC play and we think they can keep this within 2 td's.

Northern Illinois at CENTRAL MICHIGAN - CM is on a 7-2 SU & 8-1 ATS runs vs NIU but Visitor has won & covered L/2 with the underdog winning outright in both. After opening the season with an outright upset of BC, NIU lost their next 4 before coming to life and winning their last 3 to sole possession of #2 in MAC West (3-1 SU & ATS in MAC play). CM is 4-4 SU (2-2 MAC) but have failed to cover L/4 all as favorite including 2 outright losses. Both are trying to catch West leading Toledo & with NIU already losing the tie breaker neither can afford to lose this game.

Buffalo at TOLEDO - Rockets are 7-1 & in sole possession of #1 in MAC West, Bulls are just 3-5 as 3-1 in MAC play and thanks to the Rockets win LW over Miami, is tied with Miami & Ohio for #1 in MAC East. Home Team is 6-2 SU & ATS since 2003. Toledo is looking for revenge here as LY UT (-7) led 20-7 at HT & 27-10 into 4Q before allowing 24 unanswered. Who will hold onto their #1 spot in their respective division? UB has won 3 of their L/4 SU & covered 4 of L/5. UT has won 7 straight SU but is just 2-5 ATS on those games. Who will have a Happy Halloween? One of these two games will be Our Tuesday Marquee available after Noon Eastern on Tuesday!

4★ PITTSBURGH over Jacksonville - This marks the start of a 3-gm homestand for the Steelers who return to PIT following a 7 pt upset of the Rams where we cashed a 3★ Newsletter Winner! The Jags meanwhile have played just 1 "true" HG over the past 5 wks. JAX does however head North on extra rest after a 31-24 (+2) win last Thur against the Saints (GW 44-yd TD pass w/3:08 remaining). Surprisingly, the visitor in this series has won 5 straight (4-1 ATS, 12 pt avg MOV) including a 27-3 (-10') win by the Steelers in '20 where they finished with 23-14 FD and 373-206 yard edges. Despite the lack of home success in this series, we're leaning with the Steelers in this one as they've covered 8 of their L/10 overall as well as going 9-2-1 ATS when getting points inside of their home venue (JAX 1-4 ATS before a bye and 4-9 ATS in NDIV AG's). **FORECAST: PITTSBURGH by 7**

3★ TENNESSEE over Atlanta - In a very strange scheduling quirk, the Titans return from their bye week for their only "true" home matchup in a 7-week span as they were at IND and in London (loss to BAL) prior to the time off and have trips to PIT (Thur), TB and JAX on deck. The Falcons meanwhile connected on a GW 51-yd FG as time expired to knock off the Bucs a week ago (ATL 401-329 yd edge). In the most recent meeting in '19, the Titans (+3') picked up a 24-10 upset (ATL 422-365 yd edge). It does appear that TEN QB Tannehill will be missing here following an injury "across the pond" as either Malik Willis or rookie Will Levis will line up under center. With the Titans going 6-0-1 ATS following a bye and the Falcons failing to cover 6 of their L/7 against the AFC, we like TEN to get the cover here no matter who starts at QB. **FORECAST: TENNESSEE by 9**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Kansas City over DENVER - Following a 2 pt home win LW against GB and their 1st cover of the entire ssn, the Broncos are back inside of "Mile High" to take on a Chiefs squad that they've now dropped 16 straight (5-11 ATS, 12 pt avg loss) to including a 19-8 (+10') defeat in Arrowhead 2 weeks ago where they were held to just 197 yds. The Chiefs picked up another DIV win LW at home against the Chargers with QB Mahomes throwing for 424 yds and 4 TD's. Prior to their recent bye weeks the Broncos have gone a solid 7-3-1 ATS. Despite that solid mark, DEN has actually failed to cover 7 of their L/10 at home overall. With these 2 franchises continuing to head in opposite directions, another long day for the DEN faithful should be expected. **FORECAST: Kansas City by 16**

OTHER PLAYS

Tampa Bay at BUFFALO - Thursday - The Bucs return to action following a narrow 3 pt home loss LW against the Falcons where ATL hit a GW 51-yd FG as time expired The Bills meanwhile struggled in their 29-25 upset loss to the Patriots who got a GW 1-yd TD pass with :15 remaining. The Bucs have actually dropped 6 straight ATS against the AFC coming in. Ironically, their last non-conf cover came against the Bills in '21 with TB (-3') picking up a 33-27 OT win on a GW 58-yd TD pass in the extra frame. While TB has played much better than we expected so far in '23 despite LW loss, also keep in mind that the Bills have gone 14-7 ATS in meetings with the NFC. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

INDIANAPOLIS by 5 over New Orleans - Rematch of Super Bowl XLIV ('10), a game that saw the Saints collect their 1st ever Lombardi Trophy in the 31-17 win. The Saints have actually won 4 straight in the series (incl the SB) with a 26 pt avg MOV (34-7 victory in '19). This is however the 3rd AG in a 4-wk span for the Saints who head to IND after a 7 pt home loss to the Jags (trailed 24-9 in 4Q, NO 25-18 FD & 407-330 yd edges). The Colts meanwhile suffered a narrow 39-38 home loss to CLE LW despite a 456-316 yd edge (IND 4 TO's). With IND going a solid 15-8-1 ATS against the NFC and the Saints covering just 1 of their L/8 overall, we expect the Colts to pick up a victory in this one before going back on the road for the next 2 weeks.

CAROLINA by 3 over Houston - Matchup between the Top 2 picks of this year's draft as Texans' QB CJ Stroud (#2 pick) heads into Charlotte to take on QB Bryce Young (#1 pick) and the Panthers. The Panthers have picked up 4 consecutive wins in this series (SU & ATS, 11 pt avg MOV) including a 24-9 (-8) road victory in '21 where they had 28-14 FD and 407-193 yard edges. While the Texans are an AF for the 1st time 3 yrs, their previous experience in that role have seen them go just 4-8-1 ATS. With the Panthers hungry for their 1st victory of the ssn and going 5-2-1 ATS as a HD, this might be the week that they break into the win column.

Philadelphia by 8 over WASHINGTON - This marks the only HG for the Commanders in a 5-week span as they return to D.C. after splitting a pair of games against the Falcons and Giants (outgained 356-273 in a 7 pt defeat) with 2 more trips to NE and SEA on deck. The Eagles meanwhile picked up a big home victory LW against the streaking Dolphins who were held to just 12 FD's and 244 yds in a 14 pt defeat. In their meeting earlier this month, the Eagles (-9) overcame a 17-10 home deficit to the Commanders in the eventual 34-31 OT victory. While the Eagles do have a pivotal home meeting against the Cowboys prior to their bye week, we don't see them overlooking their trip to the Nation's Capital following their earlier meeting.

DALLAS by 10 over LA Rams - Following a 3-game homestand that included a 7 pt home loss to the Steelers where they actually finished with a 354-300 yd edge, the Rams head to DAL to take on a well-rested Cowboys squad that returns from bye sitting at 4-2 (6-3 ATS run dating back to LY). In their trip to LA a year ago, the Cowboys (+5') picked up a 22-10 road upset despite 14-10 FD and 323-239 yd disadvantages (LAR 3 TO's). With the Rams failing to cover 7 of their L/9 as an AD and the Cowboys going 12-5 ATS as home chalk, we feel comfortable giving DAL a DD lean in this one.

MIAMI by 14 over New England - Following a 14 pt loss LW in Philly where they were held to just 12 FD's and 244 yds, the Dolphins return to "South Beach" still having covered 7 of their past 9 overall. The Patriots on the other hand picked up a surprising home upset (+7') against the Bills thanks in part to a strong 1H start (led 13-3 at HT) and a GW 1-yd TD pass with :15 left (QB Jones 25-30-272-2-0). While the Dolphins are an outstanding 13-4 ATS as a HF and have covered 7 of their L/9 inside of the AFC East, they do have a trip to Germany to take on the Chiefs on deck. Despite that visit for MIA, we're still leaning in their direction as the Patriots are on a 2-9 ATS run overall while failing to cover 12 of their L/15 as a dog including a 24-17 (+2') home loss to the Dolphins back in Wk 2.

NY Jets by 6 over NY GIANTS - After winning 5 straight from '96-'11, the Giants have now lost 2 consecutive meetings with their AFC rival including a 34-27 (+3) win by the Jets in '19 where they benefitted from a pair of NYG fumbles. The Giants do come into this contest with injuries playing a major role over their 1st 7 gms although they were able to pick up a 14-7 (+3) home win LW against the Commanders with bkp QB Taylor throwing for 279 yds and a 2-0 ratio. The Jets on the other hand come in well-rested following a bye week. In their home meeting the week prior against the Eagles, the Jets (+6') knocked off PHI for the 1st time in franchise history by forcing 3 int's by Jalen Hurts in the 20-14 comeback win. With the Giants failing to cover 21 of their L/30 as a HD, we believe that a confident Jets defense will play a major role in this week's victory.

GREEN BAY by 4 over Minnesota - Following a narrow 2 pt road loss LW in DEN where QB Love threw a crucial int late in the contest (4 int's in L/2 gms), the Packers return to Lambeau to take on a Vikings squad on short rest after a MNF meeting with the 49ers. The home team in this series has won each of the past 4 meetings (SU & ATS) with an 18 pt avg MOV including a 41-17 win by the Packers LY in Wk 17 (led 27-3 at HT, MIN -4 TO's). With GB covering 9 of their L/13 DIV home matchups overall and the Vikings just 1-8 ATS as a NFC North AD, we have no issue leaning in the direction of the Packers in this one.

Cleveland by 3 over SEATTLE - After a comeback 39-38 win LW in IND where they got a GW 1-yd TD run with :19 left (QB Watson left in the 1H with inj following a prior 2-gm absence), the Browns head into the Pacific NW to take on a Seahawks squad that took care of business LW at home against the Cardinals with a 318-249 yd edge in a 10 pt win (SEA -3 TO's). The Seahawks have won each of their past 2 meetings with the Browns (SU & ATS) including a 32-28 road victory in '19 where they took advantage of 4 CLE TO's. While SEA has also gone 10-5 ATS against AFC, the Browns (may be without Watson once again) are 11-4 ATS in their own non-conf matchups and have a defensive unit (#1 in NFL at 243 ypg all'd) capable of shutting down the Seahawks' offense.

SAN FRANCISCO by 2 over Cincinnati - Rematch of both Super Bowl XVI ('81) and XXIII ('88) where the 49ers came away with narrow victories in both. The 49ers have also had some success in recent matchups with a 4-1 SU/ATS run including a 26-23 (-1) OT win in '21. SF returns to the Bay Area on short rest after a MNF tilt with the Vikings while the Bengals took advantage of their bye week to get healthy for the 2nd half of the ssn. After failing to win and cover 5 straight following a bye (23 pt avg loss) between '16-'20, the Bengals have won 2 straight (SU & ATS) with both happening to take place on the road (13 pt avg MOV). While the 49ers have gone an outstanding 13-1 ATS as a HF, they have failed to cover 4 of their L/5 before their own bye week. With the Bengals going 15-4-1 ATS overall and 6-1-1 ATS vs the NFC, we think they have enough talent on both sides of the ball to keep this one close.

Baltimore by 3 over ARIZONA - The Cardinals return to the desert following a pair of DIV road trips against the Rams and Seahawks where they got outscored by a 46-19 clip (SEA 318-249 yd edge). The Ravens meanwhile head out West for their only road contest in a 4-wk span with home meetings with SEA, CLE and CIN on deck. BAL jumped out to a huge 28-0 HT lead and never looked back LW at home against the Lions with Lamar Jackson putting up 393 tll yds and 4 TD's. The Cardinals have dropped 5 of their L/6 against the Ravens including a 23-17 (+13') road defeat in '19 where Lamar Jackson had 392 total yards and 2 TD's. However, with ARZ doing well as a NDIV HD (8-4 ATS) and the Ravens failing to cover 9 of their L/13 as NDIV away chalk, we'll call for the home team to stay within the line in this one.

Chicago at LA CHARGERS - SNF - The Chargers return to SoFi Stadium following a 2nd straight loss a week ago to DIV rival KC who finished with 25-16 FD and 483-358 yd edges. The Bears meanwhile picked up just their 2nd win on the ssn LW at home against the Raiders with rookie QB Bagert (21-29-162-1-0) making his 1st career start for the inj'd Justin Fields. The visitor has won each of the past 2 meetings in this series including a 17-16 (+3') upset win by the Chargers in '19 where they had 26-11 FD and 388-231 yard disadvantages. While CHI has gone just 6-12-1 as an AD, the Chargers haven't done any better as NDIV home chalk with just a 5-15-1 ATS mark. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Las Vegas at DETROIT - MNF - The Lions are back inside of Ford Field following a 2-gm road trip that saw them hold the Bucs to just 6 pts and 251 yds in a 2 TD victory and get slapped around against the Ravens who led 35-0 heading into the 4Q in their eventual 32 pt victory (DET outgained 503-337, sk'd 5 times). They now welcome a Raiders squad that suffered an embarrassing road loss to a Bears squad starting an undrafted D2 rookie at QB (LV outgained 323-235). In their most recent matchup in '19, the Raiders ended a 4-game losing skid to the Lions by picking up a 31-24 (-3) home victory (GW TD w/2:04 left). While LV has covered 5 of their L/7 as a NDIV AD, keep in mind that the Lions are 6-2 ATS as home chalk and have covered 14 of their L/17 overall.
