KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Nevada over UNLV - Battle for the Fremont Cannon. Nev leads the all-time series 26-19 but the L2Y UNLV has pulled the outright upset incl a 33-30 road win last season in OT. These tms had opposite opening games as Nev got 420 pass yds (75%, 4 td) from QB Strong in an OT win while UNLV was held to 25 yds & 1 FD in the 1H vs SDSU and lost 34-6 (outgained 424-186). Nev was without their starting RB Tavares last wk (status here ?) and ran for just 76 yds (2.8 ypc). UNLV played 3 QB's & Gilliam got the most reps (13-21 for 105 yds) but that situation seems fluid. Nev's run D held WY RB Valladay to 87 yds (4.0) and UNLV's OFF weapon is RB Williams. Nev QB Strong had 351 pass yds LY vs UNLV and this is an inexp'd Rebels secondary. Nev is in a rare role as an AF (1-0 ATS LY) but we dont mind leaning them as UNLV showed little signs of life last wk under a brand new head coach and this is HC Norvell's best team here. We'll call for Nevada to get double-revenge on the Rebels and win by over 3 touchdowns!

FORECAST: Nevada by 24

3★ TEXAS A&M over Arkansas - A&M has won 12 straight meetings but Ark has covered 2 straight. This is being played in College Station for the first time since 2012. Both tms enter fresh off a bye. The Aggies gave us 3★ winners on both these pages as well as our Late Phones in their most recent game, beating Miss St 28-14 (-4). Arkansas is 2-2 despite being outgained in all 4 games and are -72 ypg on the season. The Hogs avg 59 ypg less than their foes allow while A&M is holding foes 88 ypg below their avg. A&M's Oline has been dominant, avg 172 (5.3) rush ypd and they've allowed just 1 sack in 4 games! Ark is allowing 177 (4.4) rush ypg. HC Fisher is 9-4 as a HF. Ark is certainly much improved but A&M looks like the 2nd best tm in the SEC West and they won't take their rival lightly so we'll call for A&M to win by nearly 3 td's. Gig 'em!

FORECAST: TEXAS A&M by 20

3★ Boise St over AIR FORCE - Early on as MW foes AF went 5-0 ATS & pulled the outright upset over Boise 3 times SU but the L3Y Boise has gone 3-0 SU/ATS. Boise did not look rusty in their opener as they put up 42 pts & 450 yds as QB Bachmeier had 268 yds (71%, 3 td) and RB Holani had 100 yds (7.1 ypc) while Boise's defense held Utah St to 203 yards & 13 pts (304-45 yd edge & 17-1 FD edge at HT). AF's short-handed roster struggled vs San Jose St as they were held to 298 yds & 6 points. AF is running the ball well though (avg 6 288 rush yds, 5.6 ypc) and FB Jackson (118, 6.2) & RB Roberts (103, 10.3) lead the way. AF has held their first two foes to 268 ypd & 12 ppg but this Boise offense is a different animal. AF is just 0-2 ATS as a MW HD since '17 but 1 of the losses was to Boise & Broncos HC Harsin holds a 20-11 ATS mark as an AF. Boise appears to be the cream of the crop in the MW while AF is operating this season with a limited roster and this game seems like a giant mismatch.

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ TCU over BAYLOR - TCU had their 4 gm SU win streak snapped LY as Baylor (+2) won 29-23. TCU dropped to 1-3 on the ssn after being held to 351 yds & 14 pts vs OU while Baylor is now 1-2 in B12 play after a 27-16 loss at Texas. BU has struggled on OFF putting up just 308 ypg and are only avg'g 98 rush yds (3.0). TCU's OFF has not been much better, putting up 347 ypg & 14 ppg the L2 gms. TCU's OFF has revolved around QB Duggan as he has 902 pass yds (69%, 4-1) and leads with 153 rush yds. Both teams faced Tex this ssn and TCU pulled the upset (+69 yds) while BU was -113 yds and fell behind 24 pts. A lot of BU's offense has gone through QB Brewer (371, 62%, 4-2) but he faces a pass D that aside from giving up 332 last wk vs OU they have all'd 188 pass yds in the other 3 gms. TCU is just 2-4 ATS the L3Y as an AF while BU is 5-2 ATS the L4Y as a HD. Both teams are struggling but we trust TCU & verlan HC Patterson more than BU who has a 1st year HC and have had their share of covid interruptions this season.

FORECAST: TCU by 13

2★ Georgia over KENTUCKY - This game was scheduled for last week but was moved as part of changes due to Covid. UGA is 10-0 SU and have covered 6 of the last 7, winning those by 19.5 ppg. Last year UGA won in a driving rain storm 21-0 (-24). UGA had a bye week to lick their wounds after losing to Bama. KY put up a ssn low 145 yds LW at Mizzou, mostly because they couldn't get the ball or keep it. The 'Cats finished with just 16 minutes of TOP in the 20-10 (-3) road loss. UGA is holding foes 110 ypg below their avg and they held each of their F3 foes under 300 yds. KY has only thrown for 76 pass ypg the L3 and UGA is holding foes to 66 rush ypg (1.2). We can't imagine how KY will manage to move the ball and while the Dawgs offense isn't overwhelming, they do avg 419 ypg and we could possibly see USC transfer JT Daniels at QB before this is over. KY is just 6-12 as a HD and HC Smart is 11-5 as an AF and 7-3 ATS off a SU loss.

FORECAST: Georgia by 21

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY OCTOBER 29TH

South Alabama at GEORGIA SOUTHERN - As SBC foes GS has dominated this series, going 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS. That lone ATS loss was LY as GS held a 388-247 yd edge (22-4 FD edge!) but SALA had 2 long TD's and GS needed 2 OT's to win 20-17. Both teams are on short rest as GS lost 28-14 at CCar (HD to 218 yds), while SALA won 38-14 vs ULM. In their 6 SU wins GS has avg'd 348 rush ypg vs SALA and face a Jags run D that is only all'g 93 rush ypg (3.4) vs SBC foes but did allow 203 yds (5.1) to a run-based Tulane team and GS is putting up 249 rush ypg (5.4). GS is all'g 415 ypg to SBC foes incl 292 pass ypg & face a SALA pass OFF that is putting up 273 ypg. Despite GS beating ULM, they were -57 yds, while SALA was +35 yds vs ULM in their win last wk. SALA was 6-2 ATS LY as an SBC dog, but they travel to Statesboro & GS is 8-2 ATS there under HC Lunsford as a HF.

Colorado St at FRESNO ST - Since 2003 Fresno is just 1-6 SU/2-5 ATS against CSt. LY Fresno (-14) hosted CSt but were outgained 500-388 in a 41-31 outright upset loss. Fresno hosted UH last wk and led 7-0 1Q but were -3 TO's and the DEF gave up 323 rush yds (6.1) in a 34-19 loss. Fresno's new QB Haener hit just 54% and threw 3 int's. CSU hired former BC HC Addazio to be their new coach and CSU has QB O'Brien back (2803, 62%, 13-7) along with a talented set of receivers, though WR Jackson (77 rec, 1119 yds, 8 td LY) opted out & TE Cam Butler is OFY (knee). The CSU DEF from LY brings back 8 st'rs and should be improved however CSU has been dealing with several covid issues kept several players out of practice. Fresno is just 1-4 ATS the L2Y as a MW HF and are playing on short rest. Fresno is 7-2 ATS as HD since joining MW and while CSU is 2-0 ATS as a MW AF the L2Y we don't know who all will be available for the Rams in this game.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 30TH

Marshall by 28 over FIU - MU has won the last 2 by 3 pts each but FIU is 4-0 ATS vs the Herd. FIU enters off an embarrassing loss to FCS Jacksonville St and were outgained 444-156 and outFD'd 26-6! The Panthers are now 0-3 SU/1-2 ATS and they've been outgained by 196 ypg. MU enters 5-0 SU with all 5 wins coming by double-digits though last week their 11 pt win over FAU wasn't enough to cover as more than 2 td chalk. The Herd are +162 ypg and RB Knox has topped 100 rush yds in 4 straight games. FIU allowed 2 of JSU's RB's to top 100 yds last week and allow 213 (4.5) rush ypg. FIU has been held under 100 pass yds in B2B games and they've allowed 12 sacks in 3 games. Marshall hasn't allowed 100 rush yds in a game this year and they have 11 sacks in the last 2 games! FIU is 6-0 as a HD but tms coming off a loss vs an FCS foe are 7-10-1 ATS.

TULSA by 15 over East Carolina - Between 2008-15 Tulsa lost 6 straight to ECU SU but have won 2 in a row SU & 4 in a row ATS incl LY when TU put up 669 yds in a 49-24 win on the road. Tulsa is off a 42-13 win at USF (Fri Night marquee winner on TU -11!) while ECU is off a bye and last played 2 wks ago vs Navy and lost 27-23 despite having 372-318 yd edge. TU RB Prince is leading with

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232 rush yds (6.4) and last wk TU had 227 rush (6.1) vs USF and now face a ECU team giving up 213 rush ypg (4.9). TU QB Zach Smith (672, 63%, 5-3) also faces an ECU pass D all'g 317 ypg to non-option tms. ECU has issues with covid & QB Ahlers missed the last gm but he did just return to practice. Though they have played just 3 gms, TU's DEF is holding foes to 151 ypg below their ssn avg (#1 FBS!) and ECU's OFF has not faced this type of a DEF yet. TU is at home for the 1st time this ssn & were 0-2 ATS as a HF LY but ECU comes in 2-0 as an AD this season.

Minnesota by 15 over MARYLAND - Minn dominated the Terps LY, winning 52-10 (-16) and finishing w/a 498-210 yd edge. We went against MD for a 2★ last week in the Terps blowout loss at Northwestern, 43-3 (+11). The Terps were outgained 537-207 and outFD'd 31-14! QB Tagovailoa threw for just 94 yds and 3 int's. Minn is off a 49-24 (+3) loss vs Mich. The Gophers did hand Mich 21 pts with td drives of 21 & 8 yds as well as a fumble ret for td. Minn should move the ball much better against a MD defense that allowed 42 ppg in B10 play. The Terps offense should also move the ball better against a Minn defense that lost 5 of their top 6 tk'rs. MD has close losses last year vs Indiana, Temple & Mich St when they rushed for 150 yds or more and they should be able to run the ball against a Minny defense that was gashed for 256 (8.3) last week so we will give the Terps a lean.

WYOMING by 7 over Hawaii - 25th mtg, but just 5th as MW foes. In their 4 MW gms the home tm is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS & all 4 gms have been decided by 10 pts or less. WY lost QB Chambers on the 3rd play of the gm (In walking boot & crutches on sideline, broken leg) and rFR QB Levi Williams came in & threw for 227 yds & ran for 2 td and helped lead the comeback from a 28-6 deficit and sent the game to OT but fell 37-34. UH has been known for their pass attack but last wk QB Cordeiro led with 116 rush yds (8.9, 2 td) and RB Reed ran for 109 yds (5.2). WY held Nev to just 78 rush yds (starting RB DNP) but gave up 420 pass yds & UH QB Cordeiro threw for 229 yds (67%) last wk but the OL did give up 4 sks. UH did pull the outright road upset last wk but we will still lean WY as QB Williams has talent & RB Valladay is one of the MW's best RB's, plus WY HC Bohl is 7-1 ATS as a HF vs MW foes.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 31ST

MICHIGAN by 28 over Michigan St - MSU was 8-2 SU/10-0 ATS from '08-'17 but Mich has won the last two by 14 & 34 pts and were +247 yds LY. Mich as impressive in their 49-24 (-3) ssn opener win over Minn. The Wolverines finished w/a +155 yd edge and finished with 256 (8.3) rushing. Mich St allowed Rutgers to end their 21 game B10 losing streak last week in a 38-27 (-11) home loss, basically gift wrapping the game for the Scarlet Knights by handing them 7 TO's. The Spartans were +103 yds & +7 FD's and 21 of Rutgers points came on drives of 1, 23 & 26 yds. Mich held a much more potent Minn offense to 326 yds. MSU only has 9 starters back and are coming off a deflating loss and are still adjusting to a new coaching staff that had no spring. We think HC Harbaugh will happily kick little brother while they are down and Mich is 8-4 the L2Y as a HF. Mich St was 0-3 as an AD LY.

Wake Forest by 14 over SYRACUSE - WF is 0-2 SU & ATS. The Deacons lost in the Carrier Dome by 9 LY but that was actually in OT and WF finished with a +131 yd edge. Cuse is coming off 5 straight losses by double-digits but did keep it much closer than expected against Clemson, "only" losing 47-21 as nearly 7 td underdogs! The Orange were only outgained 455-325 and were within 6 pts in the 3Q. WF has won 3 straight after pulling B2B upsets over UVA & VTech. LW the Demon Deacons won 23-16 (+10) but were outgained 433-316 & outFD'd 28-17 but got an int in the EZ and the Hokies missed 2 fg's. Cuse is -205 ypg but they do own a home upset over GTech earlier TY. WF is -83 ypg vs ACC foes. The Deacons are only 1-6 as AF but Cuse is only 6-9 as a HD and lost in this role to Liberty just 2 weeks ago.

North Carolina by 15 over VIRGINIA - Virginia is 3-0 SU/ATS but the visitor is also 3-1 ATS in this series. The Tar Heels were coming off a loss last week and crushed NCSU 48-21 (-15). The Tar Heels topped 500 yds for the 3rd straight game and they've put up the most yds 2 of their last 3 foes have allowed. UVA has lost 4 straight. Last week they only lost 19-14 (+14) at Miami but that game was played in heavy rain and the 'Canes did lead 19-7. The 'Hoos have allowed over 300 pass yds in each of their last 3 games and face QB Howell (64%, 10-4). NC's RB's Carter & Williams are both in the top 10 in FBS in rushing this year. NC is +156 ypg and UVA is -22. The Tar Heels are far more explosive and UVA has lost 3 games by more than 2 td's and that's where our line sits.

FAU by 2 over UTSA - FAU is 2-0 SU/1-1 ATS vs UTSA. The Owls were 3 td road chalk LY and led 27-3 3Q. UTSA scored to secure a backdoor cover with 3:01 4Q left. The Owls enter off a closer than expected loss at Marshall. FAU led 9-7 3Q but did get outgained by 151 yds in a 20-9 (+16) loss. UTSA has been impressive under new HC Taylor. The RoadRunners had close losses vs UAB & BYU. Last week the RoadRunners trailed 26-13 4Q then got td's from on B2B possessions from RB McCormick. UTSA finished with +140 yd & +10 FD edges. McCormick actually leads the FBS in rushing with 867 (5.6). FAU only avg's 275 ypg in their 2 gms and while Marshall has a great defense, they also only put up 315 vs Charlotte who allows 420. The RoadRunners are 15-8 as an AD including 7-2 as a CUSA AD and they've already pulled 2 outright upsets TY.

WEST VIRGINIA by 10 over Kansas St - KSt is on a 4 gm SU losing streak & 3 gm ATS losing streak vs WVU. Last wk KSt only had 381 yds but got 2 PR TD's and blew out their rival 55-14 (3★ LPS winner on KSt -20!). WVU outgained TT 438-348 (22-18 FD edge) but TT ret'd a fumble for a TD mid 4Q & that was the deciding TD in a 34-27 loss. WVU has been playing great DEF all ssn as they are all'g just 262 ypg & holding foes to 107 ypg under their ssn avg. WVU QB Doege has thrown for over 300 yds 2 wks in a row & RB Brown (515, 6.4) is leading the run gm. Frosh KSt QB Howard played well last wk (243 pass, 2 td) but KSt's OFF is avg'g 78 ypg under what their foes allow on avg and KSt has been outgained in all but 1 gm while WVU is +199 ypg for the ssn. WVU only allows 153 pass ypg & they have 13 sks their L3 gms. KSt is 8-2 ATS as a dog under Klieman while WVU is only a B12 HF for the 2nd time under HC Brown. We had a winner with WV in our first 5★ a few weeks ago and could go back to them again for October GOM!

CLEMSON by 28 over Boston College - BC has lost 9 straight series meetings but the Eagles are 3-2-2 ATS vs the Tigers. Clem did win at home 59-7 last year and finished w/a 674-177 yd edge. Clemson was 47' pt chalk last week at home vs Cuse but only led 27-21 3Q before pulling away with 20 unanswered. Last week we felt that BC would finally get their run game going against a struggling GT defense and used the Eagles as a 3★ LPS. After not topping 90 rush yds in any of their first 5 games they rushed for 264 (6.0) and cruised to a 48-27 (-3) win. After jumping to a 24-0 2Q lead BC never led by less than 17 the entire game. BC won't be able to run the ball easily against a Clem defense that allows just 105 (2.9) ypc but the Tigers were without 3 defensive starters last week and allowed Cuse to easily surpass their avg with 150 (4.7). Clem is on a 19-5 ATS run vs ACC foes but are only 2-3 this year and BC is 21-7 vs ACC foes including 15-4 as an AD.

Virginia Tech by 4 over LOUISVILLE - This is the first ACC meeting between these two. VT is 0-3 ATS on the road this year. LW the Hokies were 10' chalk at WF. They fell behind 10-0 1Q & lost 23-16. The Hokies were +117 yds & +11 FD's but were -3 TO's an int in the EZ & missed 2 fg's. UL was on a 4 game losing streak heading into LW and caught FSU off a huge upset win over NCar. The Cardinals trailed 7-0 1Q then converted long td drives on each of their F/4 possessions. UL finished with a ssn high 569 yds and were only forced to punt twice. RB Hawkins has topped 150 yds on 3 occasions this year. VT allowed 399 (9.3) rush vs NCar & 236 (4.8) vs WF LW. VT has put up the most yds that 3 of their 5 foes have allowed we can certainly see a bounce back performance against a UL defense that allows 2 ypg more than their foes avg. VT is only 4-11 as an AF but they did bounce back off their first loss to win by 26 pts over BC so they get a slight lean.

Notre Dame by 27 over GEORGIA TECH - ND won the last meeting in '15 but the Jackets are 4-1 ATS vs the Irish. The Irish proved us way wrong last week vs Pitt in a 45-3 (-10) road win. ND held Pitt to a ssn low 162 yds including an Irish ssn best 44 (2.2) rush. Their 434 yds was also the most Pitt has allowed all season. We did go against GT last week, picking up a 3* LPS winner in their 48-27 (+3) loss at BC. The Jackets trailed 24-0 2Q then never got closer than 17 pts. QB Sims has an 8-10 ratio. The Irish avg 232 (5.1) rush ypg led by Kyren Williams (524, 5.8). GT allows 199 (4.6) rush and LW they allowed a BC team that hadn't topped 90 rush yds in any of their F/4 to put up 264 (6.0). The Jackets defense allows 48 ypg more than their foes avg and ND's defense holds foes 131 ypg below their avg. ND is 7-3-1 as an AF. GT is only 2-10 as a HD. We will call for another dominant win by the Irish as they look to prove their worthy of their #3 ranking.

DUKE by 17 over Charlotte - First meeting for 2 schools only 143 miles apart. UC is off a deceiving 38-28 (-17) win over UTEP. The 49ers trailed 14-7 2Q and were outgained 374-329, outFD'd 24-17 but were +3 TO's. Only 1 of UC's 5 td's came on a possession that started on their own side of the field. Duke enters fresh off a scheduled bye. The Blue Devils are 1-5 but +11 ypg. UC is allowing 420 ypg while Duke is only allowing 389 ypg and have played a much tougher schedule. QB Brice has thrown 11 int's but UC only has 4 in 4 games. While we do think Charlotte will give their best effort against an in-state P5 foe, there aren't a lot of easy wins on Duke's schedule and the Blue Devils are on runs of 21-6 vs non P5 foes and 25-8 ATS vs non-conf foes while UC is 1-4 ATS vs P5 foes and 7-14 ATS vs non conf foes.

Coastal Carolina by 10 over GEORGIA ST - 4th mtg as SBC foes, the home team is 0-3 SU/0-2-1 ATS. LY CCar was the favorite (-4') but were outgained 472-322 (all'd 350 rush yds) in a 31-21 loss. CCar is off a 28-14 win vs GS (held GS to 218 yds, 12 FD's) as a ranked team despite QB McCall not playing (inj'd) while GS is coming off a 36-34 win at Troy despite being -68 yds. After giving up 240 rush yds vs LA, GS has now all'd just 31 rush ypg (1.8) the L/3 gms! but their pass DEF has struggled (faced more passing tms) and have all'd 370 ypg incl 407 pass yds vs Troy. Overall GS's DEF is all'g foes to gain 57 ypg above their ssn avg. CCar is a run-first team (running 65% of plays) and are avg'g 187 rush ypg and despite missing last wk rF QB McCall has been stellar, throwing for 930 yds (68%, 11-1) and running for 184 (4.4) but his status is ? as of presstime. CCar is in a rare role as an AF (1-0 as AF LY) but still performed well last wk w/o McCall & we don't mind leaning them here.

Indiana by 20 over RUTGERS - Indiana dominated Rutgers last year 35-0, finishing with a 557-75 yd edge and held the Scarlet Knights to just a single pass yard on 13 attempts! HC Schiano got his 2nd tenure at Rutgers started off on the right foot, ending their 21 game B10 losing streak with a 38-27 (+11) upset over Mich St. After only recording 11 TO's all of LY the Scarlet Knights got 7 TO's vs Mich St (5 rec'd fumbles!). Rutgers was outg'd 369-276 & had td drives of 1, 24 & 26 yds. IU is off their first win over a top 10 ranked foe since 1987, beating Penn St 36-35 (+6) on a 2 pt conv in OT. The Hoosiers were outg'd 488-211 & outFD'd 27-16. Indiana is 0-5 as an AF and it's tough to gauge how they will bounce back after the big win but Rutgers isn't nearly as good as their score suggested last week. We will call for Indiana to win by just below 3 td's.

Ohio St by 9 over PENN ST - This matchup lost a lot of luster after PSU lost last week. LY OSU led 21-0 3Q and won 28-17 (-19). The Buckeyes (-27) were tied 14-14 LW vs Neb then outscored the Huskers 38-3 the rest of the way. QJ Fields showed no rust, completing 20 of 21 passes for 276. PSU outgained Indy 488-211 & was +11 FD's but up 1 point, RB Ford scored a td when they could have run out the clock. Indy tied the gm then PSU allowed a GW 2 pt conv in OT. The home team is 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS and the Nittany Lions are 3-0 ATS when hosting the Buckeyes but won't have fans in the stands and the cardboard cut outs aren't likely to give PSU the emotional burst that a white out normally does. We like Penn State to keep it closer than expected but James Franklin is 4-17 ATS off a SU loss and with the lack of home a home crowd we can only give the Nittany Lions a slight lean.

CINCINNATI by 7 over Memphis - These teams faced off 2 times LY with MEM getting both SU wins (CIN QB Ridder DNP reg ssn gm) incl the AAC title game, but CIN was 2-0 ATS LY. Before last wk Cincy had not played in 3 wks and led just 14-10 HT at SMU (SMU 151-144 yd edge) but pulled away 2H to win 42-13 (295-146 yd edge 2H). MEM was outgained by Temp (500-489) and gave up

387 pass yds but won 41-29. CIN QB Ridder is getting it done with his arm (723, 61%, 7-4) and legs (250, 10.3) and ran for 179 (22.4!) last wk with 3 td. Ridder faces a MEM DEF all'g 568 ypg and CIN's DEF is #2 FBS as they hold foes to 139 ypg under their ssn avg. MEM counters with QB White (1375, 65%, 17-4) and a Tigers OFF putting up 570 ypg (avg'g 165 yds above what foes typically allow). CIN is 15-0 SU at home the L3Y (9-5-1 ATS) while MEM was just 1-4-1 ATS the L4Y as an AD & we will lean with the stronger DEF as 1 stop could be the difference.

Purdue by 8 over ILLINOIS - Purdue is out for revenge after last year's loss where the yards were nearly even but they fell behind 24-0. The Boilermakers were without HC Brohm (Covid) who is their playcaller and WR Moore for the opener but still beat lowa 24-20 (+3) despite getting outgained 460-386. Both Brohm and Moore could be back for this game. Illinois was dominated last week 42-7 (+19) at Wisconsin, outgained 430-218 and outFD'd 23-8. The Illini defense only forced 1 incompletion the entire game against rF QB Mertz making his first career start. QB Peters hit just 8-19 for 87 yds. HC Brohm is 10-2 ATS on the road at Purdue and the Boilermakers are 8-2 ATS in B10 road openers. HC Smith is 7-11 as a HD and the Illini are 3-9 ATS in B10 home openers.

SAN DIEGO ST by 3 over Utah St - As MW foes SDSt holds a 2-1 SU/ATS lead, but LY USU jumped out to a 23-3 lead and held on to win 23-17 (USU's 23 pts was most scored vs SDSt all of LY). USU looked overmatched in a 42-13 loss at Boise as their OFF gained just 203 yds & 12 FD's (held to 45 yds & 1 FD in 1H) and will need to figure out their OFF issues as they face another tough DEF this week. SDSt held UNLV to just 186 yds and 11 FD's (25 yds & 1 FD in the 1H) in a 34-6 win. The Aztec ground game made a re-appearance last week as they ran for 287 yds (6.2) led by Greg Bell (111 yds, 5.8, former JUCO AA) & Kaegun Williams (84, 8.4). SDSt was just 1-5 the past 2 ssn as a HF, but won in that role last week (playing home gms in temporary new stadium in Carson, CA). However USU HC Andersen is 16-5 ATS here as an AD and this game could be a low-scoring defensive contest just like last season.

BYU by 38 over Wku - First mtg. The 1,611 mile road trip is the longest WKU has made s/1997 when they were Div 1AA. The Toppers are 0-2 as an AD TY. WKU continued their struggles last week, barely getting by FCS Chattanooga. QB Thomas started but only threw for 59 yds on 17 attempts and former starter Pigrome got some action as well. WKU was held to 254 yds against a Mocs team that allowed 30 ppg LY and was playing their first game. BYU is off a 52-14 (-28') win over Texas St. The Cougars are +263 ypg while WKU is -93 ypg. WKU's offense avg's 58 ypg less than their foes allow. BYU avg 173 ypg more than their foes allow and QB Wilson is hitting 78% w/a 16-1 ratio! It's hard to imagine the Toppers handling the elevation and BYU seems to want to put up style points considering they converted a fake punt with 6 min left LW when up by 35. BYU is 5-1 ATS TY and already own 4 wins of 30+ pts including by 31 at home over CUSA foe LA Tech.

San Jose St by 12 over NEW MEXICO - SJSt holds a 2-1 SU & 3-0 ATS record vs NMex as MW foes. LY SJSt led 26-7 at HT (324-121) and benefitted from 6 NM TO's (led to 19 SJSt pts) in a 32-21 win. Last week SJSt held a short-handed AF squad to just 6 pts and 298 yds but only put up 294 yds & 17 pts in their outright home upset. NMex was supposed to play Colo St last wk but that gm was canceled (COVID issues) so this is their opener. NMex has a new HC in Danny Gonzales (played at NM from '94-'98) and he has his work cut out for him. NMex has just 4 ret strfs on DEF but do have former HC Rocky Long as DC. The Lobos could have issues with the SJSt pass attack (#128 pass DEF LY), but their offense returns some key pieces (7 OFF strfs) incl QB Tuioti. SJSt has only been an AF 1 time under HC Brennan (lost LY at UNLV) but SJSt is on an 8-3 ATS run vs MW foes while NMex is just 4-12 ATS the L2Y in MW play.

North Texas by 7 over UTEP - NT has won 3 straight meetings (2-1 ATS). LY UTEP fell behind 52-20 (+23') and scored in garbage time. The Mean Green are off a bye after an impressive 52-35 (+6) win over Middle Tenn. The Mean Green trailed 28-14 then switched to QB Bean who ran 169 & threw for 181, sparking the NT offense which finished with 768 yards! UTEP had another closer than expected loss, losing at Charlotte 38-28 (+17). The Miners were +43 yds & +7 FD's but -3 TO's and allowed short td drives of 7, 36, 37 & 49 yds. UTEP holds foes 29 ypg below their avg but their offense avg 80 ypg less than their foes allow. NT avg 136 ypg more than their foes allow. HC Dimel is certainly turning things around but we can't see the Miners keeping up with the Mean Green's high powered offense. Sure, NT is on a 5-18 ATS run but they easily covered in their last game and UTEP is only 2-7 as an HD.

Rice by 1 over SOUTHERN MISS - SM has won 5 straight mtgs including 2 straight covers. LY SM held Rice to 139 yds in a 14 pt win. SM has been ravaged by Covid and contact tracing the last few wks and ply'd w/o QB Abraham last week (check status). They lost 56-21 (+13) vs red hot Liberty. For the 3rd time this ssn SM allowed over 500 yds (happened only twice LY). Rice was favored vs Middle Tenn last week despite it being their first gm while the Blue Raiders were ply'g their 6th! The Owls had their GW fg attempt quadruple-doin' off the upright/crossbar then missed a fg in OT and MT won 40-34. SM is all'g 76 ypg more than their foes avg. The Owls are 7-3 as an AD. SM is on an 0-4 ATS run at home and we expect Rice to show improvement in their 2nd gm so we'll call for a small upset.

Northwestern +3 over IOWA

Northwestern over IOWA - The home team is 1-4 SU/ATS in this series. Last week we picked up an easy 2★ winner on these pages with Northwestern dominating Maryland 43-3 (-11'). NW held a 537-207 yd edge and got 3 interceptions. Iowa comes in off a surprising 24-20 (-3') road loss against Purdue who was missing their HC (also playcaller) and top WR. NW has 16 starters back and added QB Ramsey from Indiana while Iowa only has 12 starters back and must replace their starting QB and 8 of their top 15 tk/hrs. The 'Cats are on a 23-9 run as underdogs and 11 of the last 21 meetings between these 2 have resulted in an outright upset. Iowa is 8-4 as a HF the L2Y but were 12-22 in that role from '12-'17. NW are one of the most improved teams in the country with a defense that allowed just 23.6 ppg last year and replaced most of their key pieces. We will go back to the Wildcats and call for the outright upset. **FORECAST: NORTHWESTERN by 6**

SMU by 20 over Navy - Navy has won 10 of 12 gms SU since '97 & are 8-4 ATS in that span. In the L/5 gms SMU has all'd Navy to gain 437 rush ypg (6.8 ypc)! This is a different Navy team this ssn as they are only gaining 186 ypg (3.8) on the ground and are having to pass more this ssn after falling behind in gms. SMU's DEF has not been great vs the run & just gave up 313 yds (8.9!) to Cincy last wk and were held to a ssn-low 290 yds. Navy just gave up 334 pass yds last wk to HOU and now face QB Buechele (#3 FBS with 1926 pass yds, 64%, 13-3) who likes to air it out. SMU has not had a ton of success running the L/3 gms (97 ypg, 2.7 ypc) but face a Navy run DEF giving up 243 ypg (5.7) & SMU RB Bentley (546, 6.1, 8 td) is a capable runner. Some may not be as high on SMU after last wk's 42-13 loss but this is a down Navy squad (0-3 ATS the L3Y as a DD AAC dog) that we think SMU can push around despite being 0-3 ATS LY as a DD HF vs AAC foes.

Texas by 3 over OKLAHOMA ST - LY Texas snapped a 4 gm losing streak to OSU but are just 3-6-1 ATS since 2010 in the series. Texas (-10') led Baylor 27-3 last wk in a 27-16 win (3★ PS winner on Texas, upgraded to our Top LPS play 4★ on Sat!) as they held BU to 316 yds while OSU took down Iowa St 24-21. QB Ehlinger is leading the way for Tex with 1481 pass yds (62%, 17-5) but has 295 rush yds (4.5, 7 td) and the Tex OFF is putting up 120 more ypg than their foes allow. OSU's D has played well this ssn though as they are holding foes to 108 ypg under their ssn avg. The Tex DEF will have their hands full with RB Hubbard (478, 5.1) & WR Wallace (401, 16.7). While OSU is sitting at 4-0 and #6 AP while Texas is 3-2 and unranked. OSU is 6-2-1 ATS the L2Y as B12 chalk but it is hard to ignore Herman's great mark as an underdog, going 16-5 ATS with 11 outright upsets. With the pressure on OSU, this seems like a prime upset scenario and we'll back the underdog Horns.

Wisconsin by 13 over NEBRASKA - UW is 6-0 SU in this series and on a 7-2 series ATS run. The Badgers got revenge against Illinois last week with a 42-7 (-19') win. QB Mertz proved to be an upgrade, hitting 20 of 21 passes for 248 yds and 5 td's. UW finished with 430-218 yd & 23-8 FD edges. Neb opened at OSU (+27) and actually led 7-0 and were tied 14-14 2Q before the Buckeyes took over and outscored the Huskers 38-3 the rest of the way. The Huskers were only outgained 498-377. Their defense did only force 1 incompletion so QB Mertz could be set up for another big performance but we do find it concerning that UW could only muster 3.4 ypc. After Neb threatened to leave the Big 10 we doubt it's a coincidence that the Huskers opened at OSU and now host Wisky. Neb is 5-15 ATS at home and 2-6 as a B10 HD. The Badgers are 14-4 as an AF and they've won the L/3 in this series by 16, 17 & 21 pts so laying single digits is a cheap price but UW could be playing w/o QB Mertz who reportedly tested positive for Covid so be sure to check his status.

Oklahoma by 17 over TEXASTECH - OU has won 8 gms SU in series & the home team is on a 7-0 ATS run. OU's OFF is putting up 605 ypg & 51 ypg during the win streak vs TT. OU QB Rattler threw for 332 vs TCU in a 33-14 win (OU held TCU to 82 yds below ssn avg) while TT got a fumble ret TD mid 4Q to propel them to a 34-27 vs WVU (outgained 438-348). TT's DEF is giving up 459 ypg & 38 ppg vs B12 foes and now face an OU OFF led by rFr QB Rattler (1518, 70%, 15-5) that is putting up 97 ypg more than their B12 foes allow coming in. OU's DEF is holding foes to 26 ypg below their ssn avg & TT has gained just 618 yds in their L/2 gms. OU HC Riley is just 4-8-1 ATS as an AF and TT is 4-1 ATS under Wells as a HD. While the angles point to TT keeping it close we expect OU's explosive OFF & reliable DEF to be enough to secure a comfortable win.

TULANE by 1 over Temple - As AAC foes Temple has a 4-0 SU/ATS lead. Despite putting up 500 yds vs MEM last wk Temp lost 41-29, while TU gave up 689 yds to UCF in a 51-34 defeat. Tulane gave up 422 pass yds last wk & for the ssn are all'g 327 pass ypg and Temp QB Russo threw for 387 last wk (4-3 ratio) and for the ssn is hitting 68% for 863 yds. Temp's DEF has been okay (371 ypg all'd, but 36 ppg all'd) and faces a Tulane OFF that has put up just 313 ypg the L/3 gms incl gaining 178 ypg less than what UCF's DEF came in all'g! Tulane frosh QB Pratt is hitting just 47% this ssn & the run gm is avg'g just 130 yds (3.0) the L/3 gms (299 ypg, 6.4 ypc the F/3 gms). For the ssn Tulane is also -101 ypg while Temp is 1-2 but are +69 ypg on the year. Both tms faced Navy this ssn & lost but Temp was +88 while TU was just +23 yds & blew a 24-0 HT lead. Tulane is 5-0 ATS at home vs AAC foes the L2Y and while we see them winning outright, this gm will be close.

Louisiana by 21 over TEXAS ST - As SBC foes the Cajuns have dominated this series, going 7-0 SU/ATS. LA is winning those gms by 22 ppg & covering by 11 ppg. This is TXSt's first home gm since Sep 12 vs UTSA. LY the Cajuns (-22) held TXSt to just 264 yds & 3 pts in a 31-3 win. LA is off a big win last Fri as they handed UAB their first SU home loss since the program came back in '17 (Won 24-20, RB Smith had 100-yd KR TD) while TXSt is off a big loss at BYU 52-14 (outgained 579-267). TXSt's run D is improved from LY (167, 4.3) and LA is not running as well as LY (176, 5.1) but RB Mitchell has 316 yds (5.9) this ssn. TXSt is gaining just 307 ypg & 18 ppg the L/4 gms & LA's DEF showed up last wk vs UAB (all'd 285 yds). LA is 4-1 ATS as an SBC AF under Napier & TXSt is just 1-5 ATS the L3Y as an SBC HD. This could be a letdown spot for LA off a big road win but we'll go with the series history and lean with the Cajuns.

ARKANSAS ST by 7 over Troy - Since 2011 Ark St has gone 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS vs Troy. The home team however is just 1-7 ATS in the L/8 games. Ark St is off a 45-17 loss at App St last Thur while Troy is off a 36-34 loss vs GST. Ark St's strength on OFF is their pass game (369 ypg) and QB's Bonner & Hatcher have a comb'd 21-4 ratio and face a Troy pass DEF that gave up 370 yds to ECU 2 wks ago. Ark St's DEF though is struggling this ssn, giving up 548 ypg & 50 ppg in SBC play and are giving up 107 more ypg than their SBC foes avg. That Ark St DEF faces a Troy OFF that is avg'g 468 ypg in SBC play incl 373 pass yds. Though the home tm has not done well ATS, Ark St HC Anderson is 16-4 ATS as an SBC HF & Troy is 0-3 ATS as an SBC AD the L3Y. This game should be high scoring and we'll take the home squad by a TD.

Ucf by 3 over HOUSTON - The home team in this series is on a 0-6 ATS slide. UCF's OFF is off another stellar performance as they put up 689 yds & 51 pts vs Tulane, while HOU was cashed in a 4★ LPS side (-14') and a 3★ LPS total (OVER 56) last week in a 37-21 win at Navy! UCF QB Gabriel still leads the FBS with 2,178 pass yds (65%, 19-2) and faces a HOU defense that gave up 400 pass yds to BYU QB Wilson two wks ago. HOU has a talented QB of their own in Clayton Tune

TECHNICAL PLAY OF THE WEEK.....DUKE

(945, 66%, 7-2) who faces a UCF DEF that is all'g 482 ypg & just 2 wks ago gave up 703 yds (486 pass) to Memphis. HOU's defense is a bit better as they are all'g 354 ypg but this UCF offense is a beast of its own as they are gaining 234 ypg more than what their foes allow (#1 FBS!). While HOU is just 1-4 ATS as a HD under Holgerson, UCF has a 1-5 ATS mark the L2Y as an AAC AF. We expect a TON of points and a close game.

Iowa St by 36 over KANSAS - Since 2010 ISU is 9-1 SU vs KU (34-14 loss in '14) but LY ISU (-24') scored 2 TD's in the 4Q to win 41-31. ISU is off a 24-21 loss to Oklahoma St while KU only got outgained by 61 yds vs KSt but all'd 2 punt ret TD's in a 55-14 defeat (3★ LPS winner on KSt -20'). ISU's best OFF threat is RB Hall, who ran for over 100 yds for the 5th straight gm (185, 9.3) vs OSU & is #2 in FBS with 716 rush yds (6.3, 9 td). KU's run DEF is giving up 213 ypg (4.9) in B12 play. ISU QB Purdy has been okay this ssn (1074, 61%, 5-2) but can have a great day vs a KU DEF giving up 254 pass ypg vs B12 foes. ISU HC Campbell is 5-2-1 ATS as an AF the L4Y and KU is 1-4 ATS this ssn (one cover was by half-pt vs WVU on late KR TD) and there is no way we can back a young & inexp'd KU given what we have seen from them this season.

Lsu by 3 over AUBURN - The home team is 17-3 SU/13-6-1 ATS in this series. Auburn gave LSU their closest game of the season LY, only losing 23-20 but they were outgained 508-287. Auburn had another fortunate win last week, beating Ole Miss 35-28 (-3'). Auburn got an int at the goal line, and had a KR accidentally touch a ball that rolled into the EZ but was ruled a touchback and the Tigers got the GW to win with 1:11 left. RB Bigsby topped 100 yds for the 3rd straight game. LSU was w/o QB Brennan last week, giving true frosh QB TJ Finley his first career start. Finley led a 52-24 (-5) win over SCar, throwing for 265. HC Orgeron and DC Pelini both vowed to simplify the defense to eliminate their blown coverage issues which seemed to help as they held SC to 55% completions and 243 pass yds. LSU is putting 486 ypg and 142 ypg more than their foes allow. Auburn avg only 386 ypg and 32 ypg less than their foes allow. Despite the visitor's lousy record in this series we like an improving LSU squad to win by a fg against an Auburn team that has been fortunate in all 3 wins.

Uab by 13 over LOUISIANA TECH - UAB is 3-0 SU/2-0-1 ATS vs LT since their rebirth. Both teams were w/o their starting QB's LY and UAB won 20-14 (-6) with a +83 yd edge. The Blazers had their 21 game home win streak snapped last week vs Louisiana. The Blazers led 13-3 but gave up a KR TD right before half then blew a 20-10 3Q lead. LT led UTSA 26-13 3Q after a pick 6 but allowed 2 4Q td drives. The Bulldogs were outgained 385-247 & outFD'd 25-15. UAB has held 3 straight opponents under 300 yds and LT has been held under 300 yds in 3 straight. The Blazers hold foes 65 ypg below their avg while LT avg 88 ypg less than their foes allow. RB Brown has over 100 yds in 4 games and LT just allowed UTSA's McCormick to rush for 133 yds. UAB is on an 0-4 run as an AF but is 9-2-1 ATS off a loss and Holtz is only 2-5 as a HD.

Mississippi by 27 over VANDERBILT - The home team has won 5 straight but that's likely to end with Vandy playing with a depleted roster and Ole Miss building momentum under HC Kiffin. The Rebels won this last year 31-6 (-7) and finished with a 512-264 yd edge. Vandy lost B2B games vs LSU & SC 41-7 each before having Covid issues that depleted their roster. Ole Miss is off an unfortunate 35-28 (+3) loss vs Auburn. QB Corral had a 9-1 ratio in the F/3 gms but only a 3-8 ratio in the L/2. The Rebels avg 521 ypg and have topped 240 rush yds in each of their L/3. Vandy is allowing 452 ypg and 211 rush (6.5). The 'Dores avg 200 ypg less than their foes allow while Ole Miss avg 133 ypg more than their foes allow and put up the most yds 4 of their 5 foes have allowed. The Dores are just 1-7 as a HD. The undermanned Commodores won't keep up with the high powered Rebels.

Appalachian St by 34 over ULM - As SBC foes App St is 4-1 SU vs ULM but just 2-3 ATS. LY App St held ULM to 213 yds in a 52-7 blowout. In those 5 previous gms App has avg'd 550 yds & 46 pts while App has held ULM to under 365 yds in all but 1 game. Despite not playing for nearly a month App did not look rusty vs Ark St as QB Thomas had 216 pass yds (70%, 4-1) and App won 45-17 (Thur Night Marquee winner on Under 69.5!) and held Ark St to 128 ypg below their ssn avg and got 6 sks! ULM's wireless ssn continued last wk losing 38-14 to SAIA. ULM has struggled all ssn to run the ball, avg'g just 63 ypg (2.9) this ssn & App is holding tms to 138 ypg (3.8) on the ground & overall App's DEF is holding foes to 115 ypg under their ssn avg. On the other hand App is avg'g 278 rush yds this ssn & faces a ULM run D giving up 247 ypg (5.2). App was 5-2 ATS as an SBC AF the L2Y and faces a ULM squad that is on a 4-12 ATS slide dating back to LY. We have no faith in ULM & don't mind leaning App St even as a large favorite.

ALABAMA by 35 over Mississippi St - Bama has won 12 straight meetings (8-4 ATS). The Bulldogs are just 1-7 ATS in Tuscaloosa. This is the first matchup between HC's Leach & Saban. Bama's 45-17 (-21') win at Tenn was costly as WR Waddle was injured on the opening KO and is OFY. The Tide avg 566 ypg and have put up the most yards each of their L/4 foes have allowed. QB Jones is hitting 79% w/a 12-2 ratio. MSU enters fresh off a bye where they surely tried to fix their offensive issues. They avg 388 ypg and are putting up 16 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. QB's They have scored just 30 pts in their L/3 gms and have allowed 3 defensive td's. Costello and Rogers have comb'd for a 7-12 ratio. Bama looks like a well oiled machine right now while Miss St is a mess. Bama is on a 19-10 run as an SEC HF and MSU is 1-5 as an AD.

FLORIDA by 10 over Missouri - Florida was out for double-revenge last year and got it with a 23-6 (-7) road win. This game was orig scheduled for 10/24 but was moved due to UF's Covid issues. The Gators lost their last game 3 weeks ago against Tx A&M and have had their last 2 games postponed. Last week we talked about this game in the Power Sweep Podcast (found on NCSports.com on Thursdays) as a potential Totals play and we ended up using Under 47 as a 3★ LP Totals play with MO winning a defensive affair 20-10. The Tigers held a 421-145 yd edge, had a 26-8 FD edge and held the ball for over 43 minutes! QB Trask is hitting 72% with a 13-1 ratio. It's hard to imagine that MO will be able to eat TOP like this against MO but Florida's Covid issues has us leaning with the dog.

4★ Indianapolis over DETROIT - After connecting on a GW 11-yd TD pass on the final play LW in ATL, the Lions are back inside of Ford Field to take on a well-rested Colts squad that narrowly got past CIN in comeback fashion prior to their bye week. In their last matchup back in '16, the Lions (+3) picked up a ssn-opening 39-35 upset win ending a 3-gm losing skid to the Colts in the process. Despite that most recent series win, the Lions do come in having covered just 4 of their L/15 overall. With the Colts needing a win to stay within reach of the front-running Titans in the AFC South, we'll call for them to get the job done here as they've gone 8-2-1 ATS in recent matchups against the NFC. **FORECAST: Indianapolis by 13**

3★ BUFFALO over New England - Key matchup in the AFC East as the Bills look to unseat the Patriots who have won 11 consecutive DIV titles. Following a 2-game losing skid to the Titans and Chiefs (outscored 68-33 in the 2 defeats), the Bills got 6 FG's in an 18-10 victory LW on the road against the Jets (BUF 422-190 yd edge). NE meanwhile suffered their 3rd consecutive regular season loss for the 1st time since 2002 LW at home against the 49ers who dominated from the start (SF 467-241 yd edge). The Patriots have owned this series dating back to 2004 with a 29-3 SU mark (19-11-2 ATS) including 8 straight wins in BUF (6-2 ATS) with a 13 pt avg MOV. This is also the first time since '14 that the Patriots are listed as a DIV AD. In fact, they've been in that role just 3 times over the past 12 years (2-1 ATS). Despite those factors, we cannot justify leaning in the direction of the visitor who has averaged just 9.3 ppg and 295 ypg over their L/3 matchups. **FORECAST: BUFFALO by 13**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ DENVER over La Chargers - Following a 10 pt home win against the Jags (2★ Newsletter Winner) where QB Herbert had another strong showing (413 ttl yds, 4 ttl TD's), the Chargers head to DEN to take on a Broncos squad that was blasted by KC (outgained 411-286 in 27 pt defeat) in snowy "Mile High". The Broncos have clearly been a thorn in the side of the Chargers over the past 2 years with 3 outright upsets incl a 23-20 (+3) win in DEN LY. With DEN on a 12-6 overall ATS run coming in, we'll call for the HD to continue their recent success here as LA has now dropped 6 of their L/7 ATS inside of the AFC West. **FORECAST: DENVER by 6**

OTHER PLAYS

Atlanta at CAROLINA - Thursday - The Falcons fell just short of a 2nd consecutive win under interim HC Morris with the Lions connecting on a GW 11-yd TD pass on the final play. The Panthers meanwhile dropped a 2nd consecutive matchup LW in the Superdome against the Saints (3★ LP Winner on CAR +7) following a 3-game winning streak prior. After posting a 4-gm series winning streak heading into 2020, the Falcons were knocked off by the visiting Panthers 23-16 a few weeks back as a 2' pt favorite (ATL HC Quinn fired after the loss). ATL will attempt to even the season series here against a Panthers squad that's failed to cover 9 of their L/12 DIV home matchups. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

GREEN BAY by 10 over Minnesota - The Packers got back on track LW in HOU against the Texans (QB Rodgers 283 pass yds & 4 TD's) after their 1st loss of the season the week prior against the Bucs. MIN meanwhile returns to action with just a 2-8 ATS mark after their bye week. Following a 43-34 upset win in TY's opener where QB Rodgers threw for 364 yds and 4 TD's (2★ Newsletter Winner), the Packers have now covered 5 consec meetings against the Vikings. With MIN going just 6-14 ATS as a DIV AD coming in and the Packers picking up covers in 7 of their L/10 as a HF, we have no issue leaning with GB in this one (6-2 ATS run vs NFC North).

Tennessee by 3 over CINCINNATI - The Bengals are back at home for a 2nd consecutive week after nearly picking up an upset win over the Browns (4★ Newsletter Winner on CIN). The Titans meanwhile nearly pulled out an astonishing comeback LW at home against PIT (missed tying FG w/:19 left, trailed 27-7 early 3Q). These 2 last met back in '17 with the Titans picking up a 24-20 home victory with a GW 7 yd TD pass w/:36 left (CIN had won 4 of the previous 5). The Titans have had a handful of close contests including just 2 and 1 pt road victories at DEN and MIN respectively. With CIN on a 6-1-1 ATS run overall and TEN failing to cover 7 of their L/9 as a NDIV AF, we're cutting off our lean at just a FG for the visitor.

CLEVELAND by 1 over Las Vegas - Following a final second comeback effort LW in CIN (GW 24-yd TD pass w/:11 left), the Browns return home to take on a Raiders squad that was hammered LW at home against the Bucs (TB 454-347 yd edge in 25 pt win). In their most recent matchup back in '18 at Oakland, the Raiders (-2') overcame a 28-14 deficit in the 3Q for a 45-42 shootout OT victory (game featured 1,052 ttl yds). While the Raiders have failed to cover 10 of their L/14 as a NDIV AD coming in, they did just pull off an outright upset in Arrowhead a few weeks back. The Browns meanwhile have routinely struggled prior to their bye week going just 2-7 ATS.

KANSAS CITY by 21 over Ny Jets - After posting 39 rush yds on 6 carries a week ago in his debut for the Chiefs (KC 27 pt win over DEN with 411-286 yd edge), Le'Veon Bell and company head back to Arrowhead to take on his former squad in the Jets who have yet to win a game thus far in 2020 following an 8 pt loss against the Bills where they were held to just 190 yds. In their most recent matchup back in '17, the Jets picked up a 38-31 victory (30-17 FD edge) ending a 2-game Chiefs winning streak in the series. While the Jets are just 3-9 ATS as a DD dog coming in and the Chiefs have picked up covers in 11 of their L/13 overall, we're keeping KC's lean right at the elevated 21 pt opening line in this one (Tied for 8th biggest line in NFL history).

La Rams by 6 over MIAMI - While the Dolphins have picked up outright victories in 3 of their L/4 contests overall, they do return from their bye week with a change under center as rookie QB Tagovailoa is expected to get his 1st career start over veteran Fitzpatrick. The Rams meanwhile head back East on short rest following a MNF matchup against the Bears in LA. Although the Dolphins have owned this series back to '04 with a 4-0 SU mark (2-2 ATS) and a 7 pt avg MOV, it's also worth mentioning that the Rams have picked up covers in 7 of their L/11 as of presstime. With a strong DL led by Aaron Donald facing a rookie QB here, we'll call for the visiting Rams to improve upon their 6-3 ATS mark as an AF.

New Orleans by 4 over CHICAGO - The Saints had a successful return from bye LW in the Superdome against the Panthers with 415-283 yd edge in a 3 pt victory (3★ LP Winner on CAR +7). They now head to the "Windy City" to take on a solid Bears squad that has just one loss on the season as of presstime. The Bears are coming into this matchup on short rest however as they return from LA following a MNF meeting against the Rams. In their Soldier Field meeting a year ago, the Saints picked up their 5th consec win in the series (4-1 ATS) by a 36-25 score (24-16 FD & 424-252 yd edges). With the Saints an outstanding 14-4 ATS in AG's heading in, the visitor gets the narrow lean in this one.

SEATTLE by 1 over San Francisco - Following their 1st loss of the season LW in the desert against the Cardinals who scored 10 pts over the last 2:28 before eventually winning in OT, the Seahawks return home to take on a 49ers squad that has bounced back the past 2 weeks with impressive victories over the Rams and Patriots (467-241 yd edge in 27 pt win LW in Foxboro). After the Seahawks earned the series sweep each year from '14-'17, these 2 NFC West powerhouses have split their meetings in each of the past 2 seasons with the road team cashing both in '19. With the 49ers covering 5 straight as an AD coming in, we'll call for the visitor to keep this one close despite the absence of a handful of starters on both sides of the ball.

BALTIMORE by 7 over Pittsburgh - After holding on late in Nashville against the Titans to remain the lone undefeated team this season (23-15 FD & 362-292 yd edges), the Steelers head to BAL having failed to cover each of their L/7 DIV AG's. The Ravens meanwhile are back in action following their bye week and currently sit on an impressive 12-4 regular season ATS run. BAL was able to pick up the series sweep a season ago including a 28-10 (+1) victory in the Wk 17 finale that featured a handful of bkps seeing action. The Ravens had gone 0-5 ATS as a DIV HF prior to a perfect 2-0 mark TY where they've outscored CLE and CIN by a combined 65-9! We'll call for the 2020 trend to continue this time around for the hometown Ravens who get the job done by a TD in this one.

Dallas at PHILADELPHIA - SNF - Key early season showdown in arguably the weakest DIV in the NFL this year. The Cowboys were embarrassed for a 2nd consecutive week without QB Prescott under center as they were held to just 3 pts, 12 FD's and 142 ttl yds in a 22 pt loss at WAS. The Eagles meanwhile survived a home scare against the Giants by getting a pair of TD's in the final 5 minutes for a 22-21 win on Thur night (QB Wentz 359 pass yds, 3 ttl TD's). The Cowboys and Eagles split their season series a year ago with both teams picking up solid road victories. While DAL has gone an impressive 15-5 against DIV foes coming in, something will have to give as the Eagles have picked up covers in 6 of their L/7 before heading into their bye week. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Tampa Bay at NY GIANTS - MNF - The Giants faithful has to be stinging from last Thur's final second defeat in PHI where the Eagles collected a pair of TD's over the final 5 minutes for a 22-21 victory. They now return home on extra rest to take on a Bucs squad that exploded in the 2H LW in Las Vegas against the Raiders (QB Brady 369 pass yds, 5 ttl TD's in 25 pt win). The Giants have come out on top in each of the past 2 seasons against the Bucs including a 32-31 victory (+5') LY in Tampa where rookie QB Jones led the NY offense on a 22-3 2H run after trailing by 18 at HT. While this series has also seen plenty of shootouts dating back to 2012 with the 5 meetings avg 62 ppg, it will be interesting to see if that trend will continue now that the Giants have avg 25 ppg over their L/3 contests (avg just 12 ppg over their F/4 in '20).
