4★ BAYLOR over Texas Tech - While BU has won 4 of the L/5 mtgs SU, they have only covered 2 of those mtgs. LY BU hosted TT and led 17-3 HT and won 45-17 (+4 TO's). BU may have turned their season around LW as they trailed UCF 35-7 late 3Q but used a 29-0 scoring run and came back to win the game 36-35. TT picked up their first B12 win LW vs Houston, as they won 49-28 despite being -89 yds as TT got a KR td and a blk d punt return for td. BU QB Shapen returned LW and threw for 293 yds and TT just allowed 335 pass yds to Houston and TT has the #78 pass D. BU is putting up 76 ypg more than their foes allow (#25 FBS). TT is now rolling with bkp QB Morton who threw for just 161 yds, and LY against Baylor Morton was just 11-34 for 152 and 3 int's. Baylor could have quit down big LW but showed some heart and now are at home with the crowd on their side and Shapen back under center so we'll roll with the Bears by a over td.

FORECAST: BAYLOR by 10

3★ CLEMSON over Wake Forest - WF has covered 6 of the last 9 meetings though 4 of their last 5 losses to Clemson were by 21 points or more. WF is fresh off a bye while Clemson just won by 17 at Syracuse and held the Orange to a ssn low 286 yards. WF nearly lost to Old Dominion in their only road game this year and lost to GA Tech 30-16 prior to the bye. OJ Griffis has thrown 6 int's and will have a rough time against Clemson's talented front 4 that had 5 sacks last week and WF has allowed 18 sacks in 4 games. The Tigers are allowing 53% completions and are #14 in our pass D rankings. Clemson outgained Florida St by 118 yds two weeks ago. This big issue for Clemson has been TO's but WF is -5 TO's in their last 2 games. We think Clemson gets on a roll now.

FORECAST: CLEMSON by 28

3★ OHIO over Kent St - Flashes are 10-11 SU but 13-8 ATS vs Bobcats since 2001. Ohio is 6-2 SU & 5-3 ATS but has lost 2 straight (1-1 ATS). LY Kent St handed Ohio their only regular season conf loss but that was 31-24 in OT as an 11 pt HF. This is a much different KSU team as they have a new HC & return just 4 starters from 2022. After their only win of the season over an FCS team the Flashes have lost their last 2 failing to cover either as over a 2 td dog in both. The Bobcats are off a bye and have won 4 straight including covering the last 3 including a 38-7 win over a BG team that LW upset Georgia Tech 38-27. Ohio has won & covered their last 8 MAC regular season games, and overall are 14-3 ATS under Albin in MAC reg ssn gms & we look for the trend to continue!

2★ TEXAS A&M over Alabama - While Bama has won 10 of the last 11 meetings, A&M won LTH in '21 and LY the Aggies were just 2 yards from pulling their 2nd straight upset. Bama had no trouble with Miss St last week, winning 40-17 (-14'). A&M has 14 sacks in their last 2 games, beating Auburn by 17 and Arkansas by 12. The Aggies are +190 ypg and 3-0 ATS at home. Their defense has held all five teams to their season low yards and are giving up just 254 ypg. Bama's big issue has been their OLine which has allowed 20 sacks (18.5%). They will struggle against this talented A&M front that is living up to billing as one of the best in the country. The Aggies lost QB Weigman for the season but Max Johnson is a quality backup who has had success in the SEC and has a 6-1 ratio. The more we look at this game, the more we think A&M is the better team and Bama is just 2-7 ATS as an away favorite so give us the Aggies outright!

FORECAST: TEXAS A&M by 5

2★ ULM (+) over South Alabama - SAla covered 5 of the F/7 mtgs but have failed to cover the L/2 mtgs incl last time here when SAla (-13') was upset 41-31. SAla is 0-4 SU/2-2 ATS at ULM. While SAla has the #112 pass D, ULM was avg g 95 pass ypg going into LW but threw for 268 yds LW vs App St where they nearly pulled the outright upset as they lost 41-40 on a FG with no time left. ULM has ran the ball well, avg g 206 ypg (5.7) led by RB Smith (258, 8.1). ULM does rank #131 in pass D and are facing SAla QB Bradley who is connecting on 65% but has an 8-5 ratio and SAla's offense is avg g just 348 ypg vs FBS foes. ULM enters this game 7-2 ATS as a home dog under HC Bowden and showed LW they can hang with the SBC's best. We like ULM to keep it close.

OTHER GAMES

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 4TH

MIDDLE TENNESSEE by 7 over Jacksonville St - These two last met in 1998 when both were D1AA. JSU is now 4-1 SU and 2-0 in CUSA play but needed a late rally to beat Sam Houston last week. They trailed 21-7 at half and 28-20 late 4Q but went 75/8, scoring with :13 left and added a 2 pt conv then won in OT. MT is just 1-4 but 2 of their losses were to SEC foes and last week they lost 31-10 (+6') at WKU. MT was only outgained 444-373 but had 3 TO's and were SOD at the WKU3. JSU has been outgained in both of their CUSA games by UTEP & SH. MT has faced a far tougher sked (#54 vs #109) and JSU has been fortunate to win their first two CUSA games. They won't be so fortunate here on the road against a Blue Raiders team that desperately needs a win.

NEW MEXICO ST by 11 over Fiu - These two just met last year with FIU pulling the upset 21-7 (+14'). Both teams enter off a mini-bye. FIU had won 3 straight prior with true frosh QB Keyone Jenkins starting at QB but lost to Liberty 38-6 (+10) prior to the bye. The Aggies are +54 ypg while FIU is -132 ypg. NMSt played Liberty much tougher, losing by 17 on the road while FIU lost by 32 at home. NMSt is playing their first home game in a month and the Aggies are 9-3 as a HF. Eight of FIU's ten losses under HC MacIntyre have been by 20 points or more while eight of NMSt's nine wins under Jerry Kill have been by double-digits. The Aggies are laying under a td and based on past history FIU will either either pull the upset or NMSt will win big. We will go with the Aggies by double-digits.

THURSDAY OCTOBER 5TH

LIBERTY by 24 over Sam Houston - First meeting. SH OC Brad Cornelisen was the OC at VTech when they lost to Liberty 38-35 in '20. SH was on the verge of getting both their first FBS and CUSA win but blew a 21-7 2H lead last week vs JSU, allowing a td and 2 pt conv with :13 left then lost in OT. Liberty is fresh off a bye and 4-0 SU/ATS in HC Chadwell's first season. QB Salter is a Tennessee transfer that has stepped up with an 11-1 ratio and 268 rush (5.7). SH has played a much tougher sked (#28 vs #123) but the Bearkats are -142 ypg while Liberty is +190 and the Flames have a huge edge on offense (#45 vs #132), plus the Flames are #1 in our pass D efficiency rankings (49%, 6-10) and SH QB Shoemaker has a 2-4 ratio. At 3-1 ATS, it's clear that SH is better than their record but Liberty has been impressive and has the offense to pull away.

Wku by 3 over LOUISIANA TECH - LT returns home after ending their 16 game road losing streak last week, beating UTEP 24-10. The Bulldogs did face the Miners without their starting QB and the backups hit just 9 of 28 passes. LT was also without their starting QB, Hank Bachmeier and backup Jack Turner threw for 152 and 1 td. LT is actually ahead of WKU in total offense this year but the the 'Toppers have the better QB in QB Austin Reed who has an 11-2 ratio and have faced a tougher sked (#86 vs #120). LT has been much better at home under Cumble, but did lose their last in Ruston to North Texas 40-37. WKU's D has struggled but did allow just 10 points and 373 yds vs MT in a 31-10 (-6') home win. The dog is 4-1 in this series and we think WKU has the better team so we are taking the Hilltoppers by a fig.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 6TH

Kansas St by 1 over OKLAHOMA ST - Both teams enter this game off a bye. OSU dropped their L/2 gms prior to their bye week, but looked to have finally settled on a QB in Bowman, who threw for 278 at ISU. KSt enters here 3-1 SU/ATS and in their last gm RB Giddens ran for 207 yds (6.9), but OSU's run D has allowed just 138 ypg (3.8). While KSt is giving up just 73 rush ypg (2.5) their pass

D is allowing 264 ypg (62%) and gave up 356 pass to Mizzou in their only other road gm TY. OSU comes into this game on a 5-1 ATS run as a Big 12 home dog since '16 and the home team has covered 5 straight in the series. OSU already announced this gm as a sellout, so it will be a hostile environment for KSt. Ultimately we see KSt getting the win, but the Cowboys will be fired up for this game and will keep it close & it wouldn't shock us if they pull the outright upset.

Nebraska by 1 over ILLINOIS - The Illini have won 3 straight in the series and have covered 4 in a row vs the Huskers, including a 29-7 (-7) win in Lincoln last year when they held Neb to 248 yds. Illinois is 2-3 (0-5 ATS!) after their 44-19 (E) loss at Purdue. The Illini only trailed 16-13 and actually had the yardage edge (200-188) at HT, but they allowed 21 unanswered in the 3Q. ILL has allowed 18 sacks the L&W and they are giving up 180 (4.6) rush ypg after allowing just 100 (3.3) last year. Nebraska was held to 305 yds in their 45-7 (+18) home loss to Michigan and after allowing just 46 rush ypg the first 4 weeks, the Huskers allowed 249 (4.9) of the Wolverines. The Illini are just 4-7 ATS as a HF under Bielema and are already 0-2 in that role this year, plus Nebraska is 15-5-1 ATS as an AD (1-0 TY) and matches up well here, so we'll take the Huskers and their coach who also thrives as an AD (18-8 ATS) to win this one outright.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 7TH

KANSAS by 7 over Ucf - First meeting. UCF's defense did allow 536 yds (281 rush yds, 7.0 ypc) & 44 pts to KSt 2 wks ago and KU's offense is capable of running the ball, as they are avg'g 199 ypg (5.4). KU's defense has shown improvement this season, but last week did allow 661 yds & 40 pts to Texas but they did play that game w/o QB Daniels who missed (back inj, check status). Backup QB bean has exp, but isn't as dynamic. But UCF's offense still could be a w/o QB Plumlee and while backup QB McClain has talent, the offense isn't as explosive. UCF is off a tough loss to Baylor where they led 28-7 HT and 35-7 3Q but were outscored 26-0 in 4Q and lost 36-35. KU is on a 6-0 SU/ATS run at home while UCF is just 1-4 ATS as an away dog under Malzahn and we like the Jayhawks to win by a td even if Daniels can't go.

NC STATE by 3 over Marshall - NCSt has won all 5 mtgs. The last one came back in '18 where NCSt won 37-20 (+178 yds, +2 TO's). NCSt is off a 13-10 at home vs unbeaten L'Ville and next week have a game at Duke, who is 4-0 on the season. Marshall won LW vs ODU but allowed 339 rush yds (10.9), however QB Fancher had his best gm of the season (278, 83%, 2-1) and RB Ali is up to 475 yds (5.2) on the season. NCSt is only avg'g 307 ypg vs FBS foes this season. MU's pass D ranks #3 this season and faces NCSt QB Armstrong who has just a 5-6 ratio TY. NCSt is on a 2-9 ATS run as a favorite, and Marshall being 3-0 ATS as an away dog under HC Huff with 2 outright upsets incl Notre Dame LY. While we see NCSt winning, this is tough MU team that will keep this gm close.

FLORIDA by 24 over Vanderbilt - The Gators get another chance to avenge a loss this week vs Vandy who beat them 31-24 as 2 td dogs last year while Vandy has been outscored 98-0 in their last two trips to 'The Swamp'. Vandy is now 0-5 SU/ATS after a 38-21 (+14) loss to Mizzou. QB Swann was out with an inj but could be back here. The 'Dores were outgained 532-300 last week but did only trail by 10 until they were SOD at their own 19 and Mizzou threw a td pass with 4:23 left. Florida got off to an awful start last week, trailing 23-0 2Q and lost 33-14 (+1) at KY. Vandy is 0-12 SU/4-8 ATS in SEC road openers, with their avg loss by 22.3 ppg. FL has South Carolina on deck but won't hold back off a loss and we can't back Vandy who has yet to cover this season.

NORTH CAROLINA by 16 over Syracuse - These two last met in '20 when NC won 31-6 (-23). The Heels are 4-0 with 3 of their wins coming by at least 14 points. Cuse feasted on a weak schedule to a 4-0 start but were no match for Clemson last week, losing 31-14 and were held to a season low 286 yds. NC is +101 ypg while Cuse is +65 vs FBS foes but NC has played the much tougher schedule (#10 vs #110) though the Tar Heels' wins over South Carolina, Minnesota and Pitt all don't look as good based on recent results. QB Shrader is off a physical beating from Clemson where he was sacked 5 times while NC is fresh off a bye. We will take the more rested team by 2 td's.

Toledo by 13 over MASSACHUSETTS - Rockets have won 6 straight in series & covered last 3 including a 55-10 win LY as a 28' pt HF. Toledo is in a MAC sandwich with a trip to Ball St on deck and coming off a big win over NIU 35-33 as a 12' pt HF. The Rockets led 28-17 into the 4Q but needed to hold on as time expired with NIU with the ball at the UT41. UMass after winning their season opener has lost 5 straight (1-4 ATS) including losing their last 2 outright despite being favored in both. LW UMass as a 2' pt HF never led Arkansas St, trailing 31-7 2Q and never getting closer than 18 in a 52-28 loss. Toledo after losing their ssn opener has won 4 straight but they have failed to cover their last 3. UT QB Finn returned from injury LW returning to form (281 yd 2-0) but if up may sit in 2H to keep healthy. They have opened as an almost 3 td AF, which is too many points in our opinion.

GEORGIA by 12 over Kentucky - Slow starts have been a trend for UGA this year, only scoring 17 total 1Q points and trailed both South Car and Auburn in the 2H. LW they were actually down 17-10 3Q at Aub but Mackey winning TE Brock Bowers took over and had the go-ahead 40 yd td with 2:52 left. KY on the other hand jumped on Florida with a 23-0 2Q and won by 19. KY's Oline resembled the Big Blue Wall for the first time all year with 329 rush yds (9.1) and 0 sacks allowed. RB Ray Davis had a career high 280 and 3 td's. KY has allowed just 297 ypg and 76 rush ypg (2.5). UGA's ypc is down from 5.5 last year to just 4.4 this year. KY has covered 4 straight mtgs which have all gone Under the Vegas total. Georgia doesn't look as explosive without QB Bennett and hasn't adjusted as well under a new OC. We see no reason to lay the points so take the dog.

ARMY by 6 over Boston College - Eagles are 6-1 SU but just 3-4 ATS vs Knights s/'97. Last met in '13 when BC won 48-27 as an 11 pt HF. Army is 2-2 SU 2-11 ATS & off a bye after losing at Syracuse 29-16 as a 13 pt AF. Eagles are 2-3 SU & just 1-4 ATS with their only cover coming in a 31-29 loss to #3 Florida St as a 25' pt HD. While Army is just 6-5 ATS as HF s/'21 they have covered 3 straight incl a 57-0 win over Delaware St as a 39' pt HF. BC has a slight Off edge (#64-#77) but Army has a slight Def edge (#67-#75). BC is allowing 4.2 ypc rush including allowing 264 rush yds & 6.8 ypc to Holy Cross. BC is in an ACC sandwich with a trip to GT on deck and coming off a 27-24 win over VA failing to cover as a 3' pt HF. BC trailed 21-7 2Q before taking a 24-21 but tied 24-24 hit the GW 42 yd fg with 2:11 left. Look for a rested Army to pull the win here

Notre Dame by 11 over LOUISVILLE - Notre Dame is now 29-0 SU/21-8 ATS vs ACC foes after rallying late to beat Duke 21-14 (-5'). The Irish led nearly the entire game with Duke taking the lead with 9:17 left then ND got a 30 yd td run from RB Estime. This is the 3rd straight week that ND faces an undefeated ranked team and they have undefeated USC on deck. UL barely got by NCSt last Thur, trailing 10-0 HT, but shutout NCSt in the 2H and took the lead for good with just 4:52 left. Notre Dame beat that same NCSt team 45-17 earlier this year though it was a 7 pt game in the 4Q and the yardage edge was about the same for both tms. While we are going to take the Irish to win this game, we are concerned about the physical toll 3 straight big games will take, so we approach this with caution.

MIAMI, FL by 18 over Georgia Tech - Miami is 10-3 SU/8-5 ATS vs GT and has won the last two. LY the 'Canes were +1'. They led 14-7 4Q and scored the next 21 pt before a late GT td for a 21 pt win. GT enters 2-3 after a shocking loss to Bowling Green. The Jackets were -21 and led 14-0 then surrendered 38 straight points including a pick-6. UM has been dominant this year, outgaining 4 foes by 246 ypg and their 15 point win over TX A&M looks more impressive every week. QB Van Dyke is back to form from 2 years ago, with an 11-1 ratio. We don't think GT is as bad as last week's result. They beat WF by 2 td's two weeks ago and only trailed Ole Miss by 7 in the 4Q. Miami has a huge game on deck vs NC and HC Key, who is 7-2 as an AD, will have the Jackets competitive in a bounce back effort.

FLORIDA ST by 27 over Virginia Tech - FSU has lost the last 3 in this series but they haven't met since '18. The 'Noles are fresh off a bye after beating Clemson in OT but the 'Noles were outgained by 118 yards and were also outgained by 117 yards the week prior at BC. VT was +2 last week by beat Pitt 38-21 and held a 427-273 yd edge. QB Drones threw for 228 yds and 3 td's. VT lost both of their previous road games, by 19 at Rutgers and 7 at Marshall. This is only FSU's 2nd home game and with wins over Clemson and LSU we don't see VT staying in the game. FSU is the fresher team and at home so we don't see this being close.

FLORIDA ATLANTIC by 13 over Tulsa - 1st meeting since 2015 and FAU's first AAC Conference game. FAU is off a bye and comes into this one at 1-3 (2-2 ATS) as they've yet to get the offense going under 1st year HC Tom Herman. The Owls are averaging just 14 ppg and 277 ypg against their 3 FBS foes, but they did face 3 of our top 35 defenses. They lost QB Thompson vs Clemson and Cent Mich transfer started at Illinois and put in a solid performance in the Ows 23-17 (+16) loss as he hit 28-49 for 256 yds with a 2-1 ratio. Tulsa is off impressive B2B wins over NIU and Temple and enter this one at 3-2 (2-2-1) and their losses have come against Washington & Oklahoma. The Hurricane rushed for 289 vs Temple and are now averaging 194 rush ypg. While Tulsa has exceeded our expectations to this point, FAU HC Herman is 12-1 SU off a bye and will make the necessary adjustments here, so we like the Owls to cover the line that opened under a td.

NAVY by 12 over North Texas - 1st meeting since Navy's epic 74-62 win at North Texas back in 2007 that is still the 4th highest scoring game in FBS history. UNT is making their AAC debut and is 2-7 SU (5-4 ATS) vs all-time Service Academies. The Mean Green are off a 45-31 (-17) win over FCS for Abilene Christian that moved them to 2-2 (1-3 ATS) as QNB Chandler Rogers threw for 321 and 3 tds. Defense remains a concern as they allowed 387 yds to ACU, including 170 (5.2) on the ground and are now allowing 501 ypg and 241 rush ypg. Navy fell 44-30 (-4) at home to USF last week and now sit at 1-3 SU/ATS. The Middies have rushed for over 240 in each of the last 3 games, but the defense has allowed 429 ypg to FBS foes with QB's completing over 67% of their throws. Navy has also played the tougher sked (#12 vs #104). This could be a high-scoring affair with both defenses struggling and we like to Middies to pull this one out at home and cover the line that opened just over a fg.

Utah by 17 over TEMPLE - 1st meeting and the first AAC game for UTSA. UTSA is off to a disappointing 1-3 (0-4 ATS) start and has played the last 2 without QB Frank Harris, who was the CUSA OPOY last year and 1 of the favorites to win that award in the AAC. Harris (toe) is expected back and it should help jumpstart an offense that is averaging just 19 ppg after averaging 37 ppg each of the L2Y. Temple is struggling with injury and inconsistency on both lines. They've been held to just 46 rush ypg (1.4 ypc!) vs FBS foes and are allowing 292 rush ypg (5.3 ypc) the L4W. QB Warner has struggled with no run game, hitting just 54% with a 5-4 ratio TY after hitting 61% with an 18-12 ratio as a true frosh LY. UTSA has played the much tougher schedule (#12 to #104) and have a healthy Harris back under center, so we'll take the Roadrunners by over 2 tds in this one.

Northern Illinois by 5 over AKRON - NIU had won 6 straight in series going 5-1 ATS before LY, when Akron pulled the 44-12 outright upset as a 10 pt AD, finishing with a 512-261 yd edge. Both teams come on 1-4 SU & 2-3 ATS. Zips are off back-to-back OT losses to Indiana & Buffalo. LW Akron as a rare 3 pt HF led Buffalo 10-7 at HT & was tied 10-10 3Q but after allowing a UB FG were sacked & missed a 48 yd fg. After upsetting BC in their season opener, NIU has lost 4 straight, but after struggling on offense putting up just 12 ppg in the first 3 they finally got it going in the 2H LW. Trailing Toledo 35-20 4Q NIU (+12) got within 35-33 & had the ball in UT territory but ran out of time. NIU QB Lombardi is off his best game of ssn (258 pass 2 td) and since he missed LY's meeting, we look for him lead the Huskies over an equally desperate Zip's team.

Central Michigan by 5 over BUFFALO - Since Buffalo joined the MAC in 1999, the Bulls are just 3-8 SU & 5-6 ATS vs CM but had won & covered 2 straight ('18 & '19) before losing 31-27 LY as a 2' pt AD. Both come in off 3 point wins LW. Buffalo started the season 0-4 and LW never led Akron until OT when they pulled out a 13-10 win as a 3 pt AD finishing with a 254-253 yd edge. CM opened MAC play LW as a 9' pt HF over EM, they only trailed once 16-14 before returning the blocked PAT to tie the game at 16. They held on for a 26-23 win when EM missed a 46 yd fg w/51 left finishing with a 411-341 yd edge. The Chippewas have the edge on both Off (#96-#112) & Def (#108-#119) and should be able to get the job done here as an under td favorite over a 1-4 foe.

Ball St by 3 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - Played every year since 1973. Cardinals are 13-5 SU but just 9-9 ATS in series. LY EM (+2) had a GW 28 yd td drive off an int to go up 20-16 and after forcing a punt ran out the final 5:33 & finishing with a 348-292 yd edge. Visitor has covered 5 straight (4-1 SU). LW Ball St (+1) only lead was 3-0 despite former Texas St transfer QB Layne Hatcher putting up 316 yds with a 3-0 ratio they were outgained 461-364 and lost 42-24. LW EM (+9) only led once 16-14 but then had the PAT blocked & returned for a tying 2 pt (16-16). They only trailed 26-23 and drove into CM Territory but missed a would be game tying 46 yd fg w/51 left. EM is favored here a roll they do not do well as they are 0-7 ATS with 2 outright losses since the beginning of 2022. With that in mind we will take the Cardinals and the points.

MIAMI, OH by 14 over Bowling Green - Outright winner has covered 19 straight but Favorite is just 11-8, Home Team has won & covered 3 straight. LY after trailing most of game BG (+7) took a 17-13 4Q lead and ran out the final 2:38 taking a knee at M18. BG after being outscored 69-13 the previous 2 gms the Falcons shocked GT 38-27 as a 21 pt AD. BG trailed 14-0 1Q but led 17-10 HT and after a 45 yd IR td led 38-14 3Q holding on for a 38-27 win. Miami after losing their season opener, Miami has won & covered 4 straight thanks in big part to QB Brett Gabbert remaining healthy as he

missed 9 starts in 2022. LW in their MAC opener Miami beat Kent St 23-3 as a 14' pt AF. We will play on the streak on a team looking for revenge for LY's upset loss.

Lsu by 10 over MISSOURI - The last time these two met LSU was off their Nat'l Title season and -14' but lost 45-41. Missouri enter 5-0 and are ranked #23. QB Cook and WR Burden were both ? last week but beat Vandy 38-21 (-14). They only led 31-21 4Q and after Vandy was SOD then Mizzou went 19/3 plays with Burden catching a 17 yd td with 4:23 left. LSU lost a wild affair last week 55-49 at Ole Miss, allowing 706 yards and gave up the go-ahead td with :39 left. LSU is +122 ypg and did win by 27 at Miss St earlier this year. LSU's offense has put up the most yards all 5 of their opponents have allowed. Mizzou has been banged up on defense. LSU catches a break with this game at Noon ET so the crowd won't be as lively and we Kelly is 38-24-1 ATS off a loss in his career.

† Texas by 7 over Oklahoma - Dallas. The last meeting of the Red River Rivalry as Big 12 foes. Both teams enter unbeaten & taking out LY's mtg (OU QB Gabriel inj'd) the previous 4 mtgs have all been decided by 8 pts or less. Texas has gotten great play from QB Ewers (1358, 66%, 10-1) and LW ran for 336 yds (6.6). UT's defense is also holding tms to 112 ypg under their avg (#13 FBS) and their pass D ranks #18. OU QB Gabriel has also been stellar this ssn, throwing for 1,593 yds (75%, 15-2) and the Sooners D is allowing just 319 ypg/11 ppg & are holding tms to 104 ypg under their avg (#18). Texas has played the tougher sked (#17 vs #56) and have a win vs Bama on the road, while OU only led SMU by 3 in the 4Q and only won 20-6 at Cincy. This should be an excellent game, but think Texas is the real deal and wins by a TD.

OHIO ST by 24 over Maryland - Ohio St has won all 8 meetings and the Buckeyes have outscored Maryland 139-31 in the last 2 meetings in Columbus in '19 & '21. Maryland did play outplay the OSU for a half LY as they led 13-10 with a 211-159 yardage edge at HT in the eventually 43-30 (+27) loss. The Terps are off to their first 5-0 start (3-2 ATS) since 2001 following their 44-17 (-14') home win over Indiana. After getting off to slow starts the last few weeks, Maryland got off to a quick start and led 21-3 at the end of 1Q and 27-3 at HT with a 259-155 yardage edge. Ohio St is off a bye and enters this one at 4-0 (1-2-1) after their hard-fought 17-14 (-3) win at Notre Dame 2 weeks ago. OSU has our #2 defense allowing just 9 ppg and 256 ypg. The home team has covered 5 straight and while both teams come in undefeated, Maryland has faced our #121 schedule, while Ohio St has faced #62 and with the Buckeyes off a bye it all adds up to another long day in Columbus for the Terrapins.

Tcu by 1 over IOWA ST - From 2016-21 ISU was 4-2 SU/5-0-1 ATS against TCU, but LY TCU won 62-14 despite being just +44 yds (TCU 2 pick-6s). After all'g 565 yds to Colorado in the opener, TCU's defense has been improved, allowing 322 ypg and just 210 pass ypg (47% in the L4 games but their run D allowed 201 (4.7) last week to WVU and the pass rush has 16 sks (9.2%). ISU is only putting up 317 ypg on offense and are being held to just 97 rush ypg (3.4). The ISU defense all'd 280 yds or less in their F/3 gms but B2B gms all'd 523 to OU and 409 to Okla St. ISU HC Campbell is 10-5-1 ATS as a HD here and QB Becht has looked better each week incl throwing for 348 in their last home game vs Okla St. We like ISU to keep this close & possibly even pull the upset.

WISCONSIN by 11 over Rutgers - 5th meeting, 1st since '21. Wisconsin has won all 4 previous meetings by an avg score of 42-8, including a 52-3 (-13) win at Rutgers in '21. The 3-1 Badgers (2-2 ATS) are coming off a bye and defeated Purdue 38-17 (-6) 2 wks ago. Despite the move to the "Air Raid" offense, the running game has remained the staple as UW is averaging 202 rush ypg (5.4) although they did lose #2 rusher Mellusi (306, 6.0) to a season-ending leg injury LW, so Braelon Allen (371, 7.1) will once again have to be the bell cow. Rutgers cruised to an easy 52-3 (-46') win over FCS Wagner which allowed the Scarlet Knights a chance to regroup after a 31-7 (24) loss at Michigan the week prior. Rutgers only trailed 17-7 late 3Q but gave a up a pick-6 which put the game out of reach as the normally stout RU run defense allowed 201 (5.0) to the Wolverines. Wisconsin has a clear edge on offense (#34-#84) but the defenses are pretty even (#15-#27) and Rutgers is 8-3-1 as an AD in B10 play, so we'll take the Scarlet Knights getting almost 2 tds here.

IOWA by 10 over Purdue - Purdue has covered 4 of the L6 gms and the last 3 at Iowa. There have been 3 straight outright upsets in the series, including Iowa's 24-3 (+3.5) win LY in which they held Purdue to just 255 td yds. Iowa is off a 26-16 (-10) home win over Mich St, but lost starting QB McNamara to a knee inj in the 1H and it appears that his season may be over. Backup Deacon Hill hit just 11-27 for 115 with an int, but the Hawkeyes relied on defense and ST's as they only allowed 3 MSU fg's (MSU Def td) and CB Cooper DeJean returned a punt 70 for a td. Purdue moved to 2-3 SU/ATS with their 44-19 (E) home win over Illinois. The Boiler makers only led 16-13 at HT, but scored 21 straight pts in the 3Q and were never threatened after. After allowing 471 ypg against their first 2 FBS foes, the Purdue defense has now held their opponents to 382 ypg the L/2. Iowa also has a huge ST's edge (#4 vs #112). Remarkably the visiting team is on a 12-1 ATS run in the series and that's a strong trend to ignore, but Iowa has had a week to prepare with the backup and are at home and the line is currently under a FG.

Fresno St by 9 over WYOMING - Fresno has owned the series of late, as they are on a 4-0 SU/ATS run vs WY and have outscored the Cowboys 87-10 incl shutting them out 47-0 the L/2 mtgs. Fresno moved to 5-0 after a 27-9 win vs Nev LW, while WY gave up 417 yds & 25 pts to NMex in a 35-26 win. Fresno's D is holding tms to just 282 ypg/17 ppg and while WY is avg'g 182 rush ypg (5.1) they gave a Fresno run D all'g just 93 ypg (2.9) and they recorded 7 sks LW. WY put up 433 yds LW but the previous gm were held to 208 yds vs App St. Fresno has had more success passing as QB Keene is hitting 69% (14-4) and are avg'g 303 pass ypg but could have success on the ground as WY's run D has all'd 217 & 214 rush yds the L/2 gms. While Fresno is unbeaten on the ground, WY is on an 11-4 ATS run as a MW home dog, but they did struggle to put away NMex & App St the L/2 gms and Fresno looks like a true MW contender and we'll back the series history.

Washington St +3' over UCLA

Washington St (+) over UCLA - The Cougars have been impressive so far in '23 with a perfect 4-0 record that included a 3 pt home victory (+3) over the Beavers (WSU QB Ward 418 td yds & 5 TD) prior to their bye. The Bruins also return from their week off here although their Wk 4 trip to SLC saw their offense held to just 7 pts and 243 yds in their loss to the Utes (UCLA had been avg 40 ppg & 527 ypg the prior 3 wks!). The most recent meeting ('19) between these 2 was a memorable one as the Bruins (+18) trailed #19 WSU 49-17 in the 3Q before mounting a 67-63 comeback win (game featured 1,377 yds!). With the dog covering 6 straight (2 outright upsets) and WSU going a solid 14-4-1 ATS against P12 foes the L3Y, it's hard not to call for the mild upset in this one (UCLA True Fr QB Moore 43%, pick-6 & sk'd 7 times in 1st conf start).

Colorado St by 6 over UTAH ST - While Utah St has won the L/4 gms SU vs CSU, they have failed to cover 5 of the L/6 mtgs vs the Rams. The 'Under' has also hit in 5 straight mtgs with an avg of 46 pts scored. USU went back to QB Legas last week after QB Hillstead went out with a concussion and Legas hit 11-13 for 204 and 3 td's in relief however USU was down 17-7 HT (-156 yds) and needed a blk'd PAT to win. Whoever starts at QB will face a CSU pass D allowing 320 ypg (74%) but their run D is all'g just 119 (3.4) with 13 sks. USU's D has allowed 459 ypg/36 ppg the L/4 gms and are allowing foes to gain 80 ypg above their avg (#131 FBS). CSU QB Fowler-Nicolosi has come on strong since taking over, throwing for 1150 (74%) with a 9-6 ratio and he'll face the #120 pass D here & CSU has two legit receivers in WR Horton and TE Holker. We feel like CSU has turned a corner this ssn and will go on the road & get the win by nearly a td.

BOISE ST by 4 over San Jose St - Boise has won 14 of 15 mtgs SU vs SJSt, but their last mtg in 2020 MW title game SJSt picked up their only win, winning 34-20 (+7). Boise has dropped 3 of 5 games this ssn, as their defense is allowing 496 ypg/35 ppg vs FBS foes. LW Boise benched QB Green in favor of bkp Madsen who hit 79% and threw 2 td's and HC Avalos was non-committal who the starter would be. SJSt is off a bye and sit at just 1-4 on the season & are off a loss to AF 2 wks ago where they led 20-10 2Q but were shutout 35-0 the rest of the game. Boise's run game is avg'g 166 (4.7) led by RB Jeanty (489, 5.1, 8 td) and SJSt has all'd 216 rush ypg (5.1). While we see Boise winning on the blue turf, while the line is slightly under DD's the could jump and if it does SJSt is 9-2 ATS as a DD dog, but regardless we think they can keep this game close led by veteran QB Cordeiro.

USC by 17 over Arizona - The Trojans remain unbeaten on the ssn following a 7 pt victory LW in Boulder where QB Williams threw for 403 yds and 6 TD (USC led 41-14 early 3Q). They now welcome a Wildcats squad that played better than expected a week ago in Tucson against the Huskies who escaped with a 7 pt road win as nearly a 3 TD favorite (AZ bkp QB Fifita 27-39-232-3-1). USC has won 10 straight against Arizona but have failed to cover the past 3 meetings (5-5 overall ATS in that stretch) including LY's road trip to the desert where they led just 17-13 in HT (eventual 8 pt victory as 14' pt chalk). USC is allowing 65 ypg more than their foes avg (#121 in FBS) while AZ is holding foes 38 ypg below their avg (#48 in FBS)! AZ has kept it closer than expected against USC in the past and Fifita showed he is capable against a very good team, we expect them to stay within the line as the Trojans have a key road trip to South Bend on deck.

Colorado by 7 over ARIZONA ST - The Buffs have been given a reality check the past 2 wks in P12 play with the Ducks (522-199 yd edge in 36 pt win) and Trojans (USC led 41-14 early 3Q before CU pulled within 7 late) picking up victories. They now head into Tempe to take on a wounded ASU squad that dropped a 3 pt matchup LW in Berkeley with bkp QB Bourquet playing relatively well (26-41-344-0-1, ASU 430-326 yd edge). LY the Sun Devils (-13) led 42-20 in the 4Q before allowing a late 88 yd PR TD to give the Buffs the backdoor. While ASU does have a much-needed bye on deck, the dog in this series is on just a 1-6 SU (2-5 ATS) run. We'll find out a lot about this Colorado team this week as they're a conf AF for the 1st time in 3 years.

Oregon St by 3 over CALIFORNIA - The Beavers head to Berkeley with extra rest following a 14 pt home win on Friday night against the Utes where they finished with a solid 358-198 yd edge (held Utah scoreless until late 4Q). The Bears had to hold on late vs the Sun Devils a week ago with a key int and SOD late in a 24-21 win (ASU 430-326 yd edge). In there Corvallis meeting a year ago, the Beavers (-12) finished with 20-10 FD and 362-160 yard edges in a relatively easy 38-10 victory. While OSU is on an 8-3 ATS run in the P12 the past 2 years, they have gone just 2-8 ATS as away chalk dating all the way back to '14. With Cal HC Wilcox consistently delivering as a HD (11-4 ATS), we're expecting a close matchup.

TROY by 20 over Arkansas St - Troy has won and covered 3 of the L/4 mtgs incl LY where Troy (-13) trailed 13-7 HT but came back to win 48-19 in the ssn finale. Troy is off a 28-7 win at GSt where they held the Panthers to 298 yds and overall Troy's D is holding teams to 95 ypg under their avg (#9 FBS) and give up just 99 rush ypg (3.4). Troy will face an Ark St offense that scored 52 pts & gained 556 yds LW at UMass where we won a 4★ Total on the OVER 55.5. Overall Ark St has won their L/3 gms and the offense has looked better but face a tough DEF. Ark St is allowing 434 ypg and their pass D is giving up 72% completions and Troy QB Watson is hitting 61% (9-4 ratio). Ark St is just 2-4 ATS under HC Jones as a DD SBC dog, while Troy is 5-2 ATS under HC Sumrall as an SBC favorite. We like the Trojans here by nearly 3 td's.

MISSISSIPPI by 6 over Arkansas - Ole Miss is just 1-9 ATS in this series. The Rebels haven't been the dog vs Ark since '12 but have 5 outright losses though they did win the last two home meetings. Last year Ole Miss became the first team to reach 700 yards in a game but not reach 30 points. The Rebels are off a wild 55-49 (+2) win over LSU where they put up 706 yards. RB Judkins finally got going, rushing for 177 after not topping 60 in his first 4 games. Ark had just 174 yards LW vs A&M in a 34-22 loss but two weeks ago they only lost to LSU by a fg on the road. Rocket Sanders should be stronger in his 2nd game back from injury. In the last 3 games following a 700 yd performance, Ole Miss has averaged 392 ypg and just 25 ppg. HC Pittman is 7-3 as an SEC away dog and the Hogs should be able to keep it closer against a tired Ole Miss team that just played Bama and LSU.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 31 over Western Michigan - First mtg. MSU just beat a MAC team last year by 31 vs Bowling Green. WMich is off their first FBS win of the season, beating Ball St 42-24. RB Buckley is #7 in the FBS with 557 yards (5.9) but was held to 50 yards LW and only had 30 yards vs Iowa. MSU is off 3 straight losses to SEC teams. Now they are a 20' pt favorite and have a bye week on deck. This is WMich's 3rd game vs a Power-5 school, with losses by 41 at Syracuse and 31 at Iowa. They have a much more important MAC game on deck. MSU needs a win here to get back to .500 and will look to build confidence against a lesser foe. MSU is 11-2-1 ATS when favored by 20+ points and we think they clear the early line.

RICE by 12 over Connecticut - 1st meeting. UCONN is just 2-16 SU & 6-12 ATS vs current AAC foes and was the dog in 17 of those. The Huskies come in at 0-5 (2-3 ATS) off a 34-33 (+4) home loss to Utah St and are now being outscored 32 ppg to 17 ppg on the year and for the 2nd straight

season UCONN has lost their starting QB to a season ending injury early in the year. Back-up Ta'Quan Roberson has started the L/3 and has thrown for 755 (57%) with a 5-2 ratio on the year, but the Huskies are averaging just 19 ppg in his starts. Rice is now 3-2 (4-1 ATS) following a 24-17 (-3) home win over East Carolina. After leaving the game early 2 weeks ago, QB JT Daniels returned and threw the game-winning td pass with 6:24 left after ECU had tied it at 17 earlier in the 4th. The Owls got the win despite being outgained 391-277 and have now been held to just 38 rush yds combined the last 2 games. UCONN is off to a rough start and now has to make a long trip to Houston where Rice is 7-2 ATS since last season, which has us liking the Owls to get the cover.

SOUTHERN MISS by 7 over Old Dominion - Just the 3rd mtg, first as SBC foes. SMiss fell to 1-4 and have failed to cover each of their L/4 gms. SMiss's offense has not been the issue lately, as they have 449 and 510 yds the L/2 gms and RB Gore has B2B games of 120+ rush yds, but the pass game is hitting just 52% on the season however SMiss has the #114 pass D. A week after barely beating an FCS team, ODU ran for 339 yds (10.9!) led by RB Calloway (236, 21.5 ypc!) on Marshall and only lost 41-35 despite QB Shields throwing for just 95 yds and throwing 3 int's and here ODU faces the #100 pass D. ODU's OL had 26 sks all'd the F/4 gms but all'd just 1 LW. While SMiss has struggled, they need a win here if they want any shot at a bowl game so we'll take them by a td.

Urb by 8 over UAB - 1st meeting since '04 and this is the 1st AAC home game for UAB. The Blazers are 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS in conf home openers s/'17, but that was under the previous coaching regime. New HC Trent Difer's UAB squad is just 1-4 (3-2 ATS) and has yet to beat an FBS foe, but they have been much more competitive the last few weeks, including in their 35-23 (+21) loss at Tulane last week in which they actually led 20-14 at HT with a 216-157 yard edge. They fell behind 28-20 in the 3Q and got within 5 with 5 mins left, but Tulane was able to run pout most of the clock on the clinching TD drive. UAB QB Jacob Zeno continued his impressive play and has now thrown for 1,442 yds (76%) with a 8-4 ratio. The UAB defense continues to be the major area of concern as they are allowing 44 ppg and 501 ypg vs FBS foes, including 219 rush ypg. USF have won 2 straight after their 44-30 (+4) win at Navy and are on a 3-0 ATS run. QB Byrum Brown has thrown for 773 (76%) with a 5-0 ratio over the last 2 games as the Bulls have averaged 516 ypg in those 2. USF HC Golesh appears to have his program a little bit further along than Difer does at this point and we really like the Bulls offense vs the Blazers defense (#123), so our lean is on USF in this one.

Michigan by 27 over MINNESOTA - The Wolverines have won 9 of 10 in the series (8-2 ATS) and have won 17 straight at Minnesota and have covered 6 of 7 here. Michigan (5-0, 1-3-1 ATS) is off an impressive 45-7 (-18) win at Nebraska in which they led 28-0 at HT with 247-121 yard edge and didn't allow any points until late in the 4Q. The Wolverines are averaging 184 (4.9) rush ypg and QB JJ McCarthy is hitting an efficient 79% with a 10-3 ratio. The Michigan defense is allowing just 6 ppg (#1 NCAA) and 246 ypg (#4) with just 86 ypg allowed on the ground. Minnesota is off a 35-24 (-10) win over Louisiana that moved them to 3-2 (1-4 ATS). The Gophers actually trailed 17-14 at HT and were outgained 211-153, but scored 21 straight pts to take a 35-17 lead before allowing a last td for the final margin. Minny is avergaing 193 (4.7), but played without leading rusher Darius Taylor (532, 6.1) last week and his status is uncertain for this one. QB Kallikmanis is hitting just 59% with a 5-4 ratio and just 156 pass ypg. Minnesota's pass game has been ineffectual to this point and a 1 dimensional team vs Michigan is bad news, so we expect the Wolverines to continue their series domination and win by almost 4 tds.

LOUISIANA by 4 over Texas St - LA has won all 10 mtgs SU and have covered 9 of those games and have won those gms by an avg of 24 pts. The Cajuns are off an 11 pts loss at Minn where they led 17-14 HT (+58 yds) but all'd 21 unanswered pts and got a late td to make it 35-24. TXSt jumped out to a 28-3 lead 1Q and 42-10 HT (+163 yds) but all'd SMiss to cut it to 42-36 4Q before TXSt put the game away with a late td. LA has been tied or had the lead at HT in all 5 gms but have lost twice and all'd the UAB and Buffalo gms to appear closer than they were as LA is allowing just 127 ypg/7 ppg in the 1H but 210 ypg/22 ppg in the 2H of games and face TXSt QB Finley who is hitting 73% (10-1 ratio) and the run game is avg'g 284 ypg (7.8) the L/3 gms. TXSt has covered 4 of 5 gms TY but the line is nearly a pick'em and all the Cajuns have to do is win outright, which we think they do and TXSt has played just the #109 sked & have let tms back in games, so we'll roll with the Cajuns.

TUESDAY OCTOBER 10TH

Coastal Carolina at APPALACHIAN ST - App St has won 4 of the 6 mtgs SU as FBS foes and the teams are both 3-3 ATS. The Packers have won 8 straight in the series (21 pt avg MOV) including a 42-24 (-5) win in '19 where former QB Aaron Rodgers threw for 429 yards and 6 tll TD's. With the Packers getting healthier after LW's return of RB Aaron Jones and WR Christian Watson along with potentially turning this contest into a neutral venue with a large amount of "Cheese Heads" traveling West (Steelers fans packed this stadium a few wks ago in their upset win), we expect GB to grab the victory in this one as they're 4-0 ATS before a bye. **FORECAST: Green Bay by 10**

3★ Houston over ATLANTA - The Falcons return home following a trip to London that saw them forced into 3 TO's in a 23-7 defeat (ATL 300-287 yd edge). The Texans meanwhile head East after a blowout win against the Steelers where rookie QB Stroud had another impressive outing (306 pass yds & 2 TD). This marks the 6th all-time meeting between the Texans and Falcons with ATL leading the series 3-2. In their most recent meeting ('19), the Texans (-4) put up 37 pts in the 2H of an eventual 53-32 shootout victory (HOU 31-22 FD & 592-373 yd edges). While the Texans have failed to cover 11 of their L/15 as a NDIV AD, the Falcons have gone just 3-9-1 ATS as home chalk and could be jet lagged after last week's trip. **FORECAST: Houston by 7**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ † Jacksonville over Buffalo - London. The Jags are back in London for the 2nd consecutive week following a 16 pt win over the Falcons where they took advantage of 3 ATL TO's including a 61-yd IR TD. The Bills meanwhile head across the pond after a successful home meeting against rival MIA with Josh Allen finishing with 337 tll yds and 5 TD's. In their most recent meeting back in '21, the Jags (+14) picked up a surprising upset against the Bills in a 9-6 slugfest. BUF has also played one prior contest in England back in '15 which also happened to be against JAX (34-31 Jags win!). While the Bills have covered 5 of the past 6 contests overall, B2B contests in their "home away from home" for the Jags has us calling for the mild upset. **FORECAST: Jacksonville by 6**

OTHER PLAYS

Chicago at WASHINGTON - Thursday - This marks the only HG in a 4-week span for the Commanders following a visit LW to PHI (3 pt OT loss, QB Howell 29-41-290-1-0) and a pair of trips to ATL and NYG on deck. The Bears meanwhile are back on the road for the 3rd time in 4 wks after a home meeting against the Broncos where they blew a 3 TD lead in the eventual 31-28 defeat (**4★ Game of the Month Winner on Over 46'**). The Bears have dropped 8 of the L/9 (2-7 ATS) against the Commanders including a 12-7 defeat LY in Soldier Field despite having 20-14 FD and 392-214 yd edges (-2 TO's). While CHI is also 2-8-1 ATS as an AD, the Commanders haven't been any better in a home chalk role with just a 5-10 ATS mark. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

DETROIT by 12 over Carolina - Following a Thur Night trip to Lambeau where they dominated throughout (led 27-3 at HT, RB Montgomery 121 rush yds & 3 TD in return from inj), the Lions are back inside of Ford Field for the only time in a 4-week span (at TB & BAL on deck) to take on a Panthers squad that suffered an 8 pt home loss LW against the Vikings despite a 6 pt HT lead (rookie QB Young 25-32-204-0-0 in return from inj). The Panthers have picked up wins in 8 of the L/10 (5-4-1 ATS) against the Lions including a 37-23 (+2) victory LY in Charlotte where they finished with 320 yards on the ground (7.4). CAR has however failed to cover 6 of their L/9 as a NDIV AD. With DET an outstanding 15-5 ATS at home and covering 12 of their L/14 overall, we have no issue laying the points in this one.

Tennessee by 7 over INDIANAPOLIS - Following an OT loss LW against the Rams in a game that they overcame a 23-0 deficit in the 3Q (rookie QB Richardson 256 tll yds & 3 TD in return from injury), the Colts remain at home to take on a Titans squad that finished with 23-14 FD and 400-211 yd edges in a 27-3 victory over CIN (**3★ LP Winner on Under 41'**). The Titans have recorded 5 consecutive wins (SU & ATS, 9 pt avg MOV) against the Colts including a 24-17 (+3) win here LY where IND actually finished with a 365-243 yard edge (-3 TO's). While the Titans do have a trip to London on deck, they have covered 8 of their L/12 overall against the AFC South which doesn't bode well for a Colts team that's just 4-11-1 ATS in their own DIV contests.

MIAMI by 13 over NY Giants - The rough early stretch continues for the Giants as they head to "South Beach" following a MNF meeting with the Seahawks and have another road trip on deck in BUF (4 AC's in 5 wks!). The Dolphins meanwhile went from putting up 70 pts the week prior vs DEN to allowing 48 pts LW against the Bills in a 4 TD defeat. After losing 4 straight to the Giants from '07-'19 (7 pt avg defeat), the Dolphins (-6) held NY to just 250 yards in the 20-9 victory in '21. Although the Giants are an outstanding 5-0 ATS vs the AFC and 6-2 ATS as an AD, we expect the Dolphins to bounce back and improve upon their 11-4 ATS run as a HF.

New Orleans by 4 over NEW ENGLAND - After their only HG in a 5-wk span LW against the Bucs where they had a 353-197 yd deficit in a 17 pt defeat (banged-up QB Carr 23-37-127-0-0), the Saints head into Foxboro (at HOU on deck) to take on a NE squad that's home for the 1st time in 3 wks following a narrow road victory against the Jets and a disastrous trip to DAL where they trailed 28-3 at HT in the eventual 35 pt defeat (worst HT deficit in Belichick's career). In their most recent meeting in '21, the Saints (+2) picked up a 28-13 road victory despite being outgained 300-252 (NE 3 int's). While Carr's shoulder will likely still be ailing again in this one, the Saints could steal away a victory as they've gone 12-4-1 ATS as an AD (NE 1-7 ATS run).

Baltimore by 7 over PITTSBURGH - The Ravens are in the middle of a 3-game stretch away from home following a 28-3 win in CLE (Browns w/o QB Watson, BAL 296-166 yd edge) and a trip to London on deck to face the Titans. The Steelers return home after a 2-game road trip that saw them knock off the Raiders in "Sin City" and be outFD'd (24-12) and outgained (451-225) by large margins in a 24 pt loss to HOU (QB Pickett left w/inj). While the Ravens are on just a 3-7 ATS run inside of the AFC North and the Steelers have collected wins in 5 of the L/6 (4-2 ATS) against their rival, the home team actually dropped both contests a year ago. With injury questions also an issue with PIT, the Ravens get the win and cover in this one.

Cincinnati by 2 over ARIZONA - This is a clear sandwich game for the Cardinals who dropped a 19 pt contest LW on the road against DIV rival SF (QB Dobbs 265 pass yds & 2 TD) and have B2B NFC West trips to the Rams and Seahawks on deck. They now welcome a Bengals

team that fell to 1-3 on the year after a 27-3 road loss LW in Nashville where they were held to just 211 yards (QB Burrow 20-30-165-0-0). The Cardinals have grabbed victories in 4 of the L/5 against the Bengals (3-2 ATS) including a 26-23 (+3) road win in '19 where they got a GW 31-yd FG as time expired (ARZ 514-370 yd edge). With that impressive series history and knocking off the Cowboys as a DD home dog 2 weeks ago, we'll call for ARZ to stay within a FG here as they've gone 8-3 ATS as a NDIV HD.

LA RAMS by 3 over Philadelphia - Following a narrow OT win LW at home against DIV rival WAS where QB Hurts threw for 319 pass yds and 2 TD's, the Eagles head on the road for B2B weeks. Their 1st opponent is a Rams squad that also picked up an OT win LW in IND in a game that they led 23-0 in the 3Q (LAR 27-19 FD & 467-329 yd edges). The Rams (+1) ended a 6-game losing streak to the Eagles in their most recent meeting in '20 finishing with a 449-363 yard edge. With the Rams also going a solid 4-1-1 ATS as a HD and the Eagles failing to cover 10 of their L/15 as away chalk, we wouldn't be surprised if PHI is handed their 1st loss of the ssn in this one.

DENVER by 6 over NY Jets - This marks the only away matchup for the Jets in a 5-wk span as they head to DEN following a narrow home defeat Sun Night home against the Chiefs where they actually stormed back from an early 17-0 deficit to tie it in the 3Q. The Broncos meanwhile are in the midst of just 1 HG in a 4-wk span as they return to "Mile High" after a 70-20 beatdown in MIA and a 31-28 comeback win in CHI where QB Wilson threw for 223 yds and 3 TD's (CHI 26-17 FD & 471-311 yd edges). In their trip to DEN a year ago, the Jets (-1) picked up a 16-9 victory despite the Broncos finishing with 21-10 FD and 324-260 yard edges. While the Jets have plenty of bulletin board material following some press comments by Sean Payton about former DEN HC and current NYJ OC Nathaniel Hackett, trusting QB Zach Wilson on the road has never been wise (NYJ on a 2-7 overall ATS run!).

Kansas City by 2 over MINNESOTA - Rematch of Super Bowl IV (1969) where the Chiefs grabbed a 23-7 victory. The Chiefs are fresh off of a narrow 3 pt win against the Jets (tied in 4Q, Mahomes 18-30-203-1-2) while the Vikings picked up their 1st win of the ssn with a 21-13 victory against the Panthers where we cashed a **3★ LP Winner!** In their most recent meeting in '19, the Chiefs (+4) picked up a 26-23 victory despite being without the injured Mahomes. While KC has also covered 7 of their L/8 against the NFC, laying more than a FG could be risky as MIN has been the king of one-score games and have gone 18-8 ATS when getting points inside of their home venue.

Dallas at SAN FRANCISCO - SNF - The 49ers are at home for a 3rd straight week following easy wins over the Giants (26-10 FD & 441-150 yd edges in 18 pt victory) and Cardinals (RB McCaffrey 177 tll yds & 4 TD in 19 pt victory). The Cowboys meanwhile begin a rough 2-game road trip (at LAC on MNF after a 35-3 home win over the Patriots where they allowed just 10 FD's and 253 yds). The Cowboys/49ers rivalry has been played 39 times (incl 9 postssn matchups). The most recent meeting came in LY's DIV Rnd with SF (-4) picking up a 19-12 victory (DAL held to 15 FD's & 282 yds). While the 49ers (1st time in franchise history w/30+ pts in each of F/4 gms) are 12-1 ATS as home chalk, the Cowboys have done well in the dog role with an 8-3 ATS mark. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**
