The Post Draft Issue grades a team's offseason a little differently than most. The grades we put into Power Sweep predict whether a team's record will improve or decline for the upcoming season. We take EVERYTHING into account. Included in the analysis are coaching changes, the NFL Draft, Free Agent signings, Free Agent losses and even favorable or unfavorable schedules. The "A" & "D" grades have been extremely accurate over the years. We spend a great deal of time and effort making these grades and while there was no list in '11 (work stoppage), here is a recap of the past 30 years as well as the record from the last 15 years with grades ('09, '10 & '12-'24).

## BUFFALO BILLS GRADE: B-

OFFENSE 359 ypg (#10) Bills: +17.6 ypg (#9) DEFENSE 342 ypg (#17)

**Overview:** While the Bills have strung together an 84-35 record the past 7 years, they have yet to make it to the Super Bowl. The Bills were +67.3 ypg which was 5th best in the NFL in '23 but last year were only +17.6 which was #9. They came up 3 points short in Kansas City in the AFC Title game after a 13-4 regular season. They add DE Joey Bosa, DT Ogunjobi plus WR's Moore & Palmer. They lose WR's Cooper, Hollins, TE Morris as well as CB Douglas. Their first 5 picks of the draft were all on defense including #1DC CB Hairston. Signs pointing down are that they were +24 in TO's, rate a -7.2 in our YPG factor and had an offensive YPP of 11.63. The Bills still have 6 games vs their friendly AFC East and should improve on that YPG but can they reach their first Super Bowl since 1993?

## MIAMI DOLPHINS GRADE: B+

**Overview:** Tua Tagovailoa was just 376 yards short of 5,000 and their 1-2 punch at running backs put up a combined 1,812 yds and 26 TD's. Miami had their 4th straight winning year in '23, losing on the frozen tundra at Arrowhead in the playoffs. They were +83 ypg in '23. Last year Tua missed 6 games and Miami dropped to +11 ypg and finished just 8-9 and missed the playoffs. Miami loses 145 starts and only added 63. They only had 2 picks in the first 4 rounds of the draft. The big question is will Tua stay healthy all season. If he does, they still have talent and should get back to a winning mark. The WR Hill offseason drama and HC McDaniel's lack of discipline could have them in for another losing if it doesn't get fixed. They did lose some key players and the Vegas total is 7.5.

Last year, they were 2-7 when QB Lawrence missed the last 8 games, and they were 4-13 and -84 ypg (#31). Jacksonville was 13-3 in a 16-game span before their current run. This year, they traded up for Travis Hunter and have a new Head Coach in Liam Coen. The metrics are all pointing up, as they were -15 in TO's, had an amazing SEVEN net close losses and rate a Stock Market indicator of +5. It should be easy to improve on last year's 4 wins and Vegas agrees with a win total of 7.5. A healthy QB Lawrence is the key.

They also add Daniel Jones at QB and #1DC TE Tyler Warren. They did have 3 Net Close wins last year and the up-down indicators are mostly neutral. The Vegas total is just 7.5 wins. This is not a bad team, but they also do not look like a playoff contender. It should be more of the same from the last two years.

In '23, they were #28 on offense and -46.9 ypg (#27). The Titans let go their successful HC Mike Vrabel and Brian Callahan replaced him. RB Derrick Henry was also let go. The Titans improved to just -7 ypg (#20), but the record did not and they have now gone from 12 to 7 to 6 and just 3 wins last year. Adding Cam Ward is a large upgrade at QB and the Titans added some solid OL in free agency. They added 118 starts overall but they lost 141. So the question is, will the defense be up to last year's standards (#2)? Tennessee was -16 in TO's and all indicators are pointing up. They will have an improved record (Vegas total 5.5) and the defense should still be solid, so this is an improved team.

The O-Line was a weakness and they lose their top guy - LT Tunsil. They added 113 starts in free agency and lost 79, but we like the addition of two Iowa St WR's. They were +10 in TO's and had 3 Net Close wins, but look like a Super Bowl contender and the Vegas Total is 9.5 wins.

Last year we gave them a B+ grade and they improved to 15-2 were #16 on offense and #9 on D (+7 ypg) with close escapes weekly. They were dominated by Philly in the Super Bowl. This year they add 34 starts and lose 65 in free agency. Injuries hurt the offense in '24 so they should be more potent. All metrics point down as they had TEN Net Close Wins and rate a -12.3 in our YPG metric. They may be a stronger team but won't match 15 wins (Vegas Total is 11.5 wins).
