4★ BOISE ST over Air Force (Fri) - Boise St is on a 5-1 SU/ATS run vs AF. After starting 8-0 AF has now dropped 3 straight while Boise rallied around interim HC Danielson and won 45-10 at USU. Despite rotating QB's and missing RB Jeanty for 2 games, Boise is avg'g 465 ypg/37 ppg the L/4 and LW RB Holani ran for 178 (11.8) and Jeanty returned. AF just allowed a ssn-high 465 yds to UNLV and snapped a 17 gm streak of holding tms to under 30 pts. AF's offense has only avg'd 312 ypg/18 ppg the L/5 gms. Boise sees the AF option every year & TY their run D is allowing just 109 ypg (3.6) vs MW foes. The Falcons have struggled on offense with QB Larrier and RB Michel both missing their L/2 games. Boise has the huge edge on offense (#37/#100) and have played the tougher sked (#76/#129). The winner here goes to the MW title game & we like Boise at home by nearly 3 tds'.

FORECAST: BOISE ST by 20

3★ LOUISVILLE over Kentucky - The Cardinals clinched a spot in the ACC Title game by beating Miami 38-31 while KY has lost 5 of their last 6 including LW at South Car 17-14 (+2). The difference in this game has often been in the trenches but KY's Big Blue Wall has holes in it this year, only rushing for 135 ypg and KY has been held under 300 yds in 5 of their L/6. UL is only allowing 98 rush ypg (3.3). KY doesn't have a single win over a team that is bowl eligible while UL has 7 including a 13 pt home win over Notre Dame! After spending the last 4 years letting KY push them around, we think it's time UL pushes back with over a 2 td win in the Governor's Cup!

FORECAST: LOUISVILLE by 17

3★ Utsa (+) over TULANE (Fri) - Winner of this game goes to the AAC Title game. Utsa started 1-3 but they've been dominant in conference play (+19 ppg, +100 ypg), going 7-0 SU/6-1 ATS. Tulane had their first AAC win by more than 14 pts last week when they beat FAU 24-8 (-8). The Green Wave are just +7 ppg and +59 ypg in AAC play. Utsa has the edge on offense (#48 vs #87) but Tulane does have the edge on D (#26 vs #45) and has our #1 ST's unit. The Green Wave are on a 2-6 ATS run with wins of 7 or less against NT, Rice, EC and Tulsa. The Roadrunners have clearly been the better team lately. They are 29-3 SU in conf play under Traylor and getting 3 pts here!

FORECAST: Utsa by 6

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Notre Dame over STANFORD - This is largest spread in this series since '06. While the Irish may be disappointed in a 3 loss ssn, they will be looking for a little revenge here as they had won & covered 3 straight before being upset 16-14 LY as a 16' pt HF, being outgained 385-301. Stanford is coming off a 27-15 loss (+7) vs their Rival Cal. Irish are 5-0 SU & 4-1 ATS as a DD Favorite (all 20+). Against their only common foe USC, ND won 48-20 allowing 302 yds while Stanford lost 56-10 allowing 573 yds, ND is off a 45-7 win over WF & won't hesitate to roll over another weak foe.

FORECAST: Notre Dame by 34

2★ Navy (+) over SMU - Navy has often kept this series close, losing the last two by 6 & 7 points as DD dogs and the have covered 7 of the L/10 mtgs. SMU needs a win here to clinch the AAC Title game. They had dominated AAC competition until LW when they led Memphis 38-28 (-9) but gave up a backdoor covering td with 53 left. The Mustangs are +179 ypg vs AAC foes while Navy is -53 but the Middies are off a bye while SMU would be happy to just win and get ready for next week. Navy is 6-0 as away dogs. They did only lose to Memphis by 4 earlier this year and their largest loss in conference play is by just 14 points so we think they easily cover this inflated line.

FORECAST: SMU by 13

THURSDAY NOVEMBER 23rd

Mississippi at MISSISSIPPI ST - MSU won this game last year 24-22 in what turned out to be Mike Leach's final game. QB Rogers and RB Marks both ret'd from injury last week and led MSU to a 41-20 (-18) win over Southern Miss though that final was misleading as MSU got a 59 yd td run and 60 yd IR td in the L/7:14. Ole Miss' only losses this year are to Bama and UGA and they are +146 ypg in all others. The Egg Bowl is full of juicy trends. The home team is 0-8 ATS, the underdog is 8-2 ATS with 6 outright upsets and the Under has hit 7 straight. Which angle will we rely on for Thanksgiving Night?

FRIDAY NOVEMBER 24th

Miami, FI by 5 over BOSTON COLLEGE - UM is 15-3 SU/10-8 ATS vs BC since '85 but these two haven't met since 2018. BC had a 5 game winning streak but have lost their last two by 26 vs VTech and last Thursday they lost 24-16 (+3) at Pitt who was just 2-8 coming in. The 'Canes 31 points and 486 yards was their best offensive output since Sept but their D had their 2nd worst performance of the ssn (470 yds all'd) and lost 38-31. UM is just 3-7 as an AF while BC is 15-6-1 as a HD. The Eagles should have a better effort on Senior Day and UM has no ACC wins by more than 8 points so we say take the points.

Ohio by 17 over AKRON - Against 6 common foes Ohio is 4-2 SU & ATS (all as Fav) outscoring them by 27-18 avg' with an avg 338-273 yd edge. Akron is 1-5 SU & 1-4-1 ATS (2 as Fav) being outscored 29-13 & outgained 334-264. Ohio saw their MAC Championship dreams end LW, but covered vs CM 34-20 as an 11 pt HF. Akron saw their bowl hopes end late Oct but has still kept playing, beating KSU, holding MAC East Champ Miami to 19 pts & taking EM to OT LW losing 30-27 as 3' pt AD. Ohio (4-4 ATS as Fav) has opened as 2 td AF and with no MAC Title game on deck they won't hesitate to win big over a bad team.

Toledo by 8 over CENTRAL MICHIGAN - CM needs a win to be bowl eligible. Toledo has MAC Championship on deck but at 10-1, are still in the mix for a New Years Day 6 Bowl spot for top non-P5 team being ranked (#23) for first time this ssn. LW CM failed to cover as an 11 pt AD losing 34-20 at Ohio. UT (-10) pulled off a miracle 32-31 win at rival BG after trailing 28-10 at HD (On 4th down GW 59 yd td pass w/1:45 left). . Vs 5 common foes UT is 5-0 SU but 2-3 ATS (+14 ppg & +131 ypg) while CM is 2-3 SU & 1-4 ATS (-7 ppg & -27 ypg). Still UT has opened as an almost 2 tf AF & is just 2-5 ATS as a DD Fav vs FBS tms this ssn. Take a focused CM plus the pts.

Iowa by 3 over NEBRASKA - Iowa has clinched a spot in the B10 champ, while Nebraska is looking to become bowl eligible. The Hawkeyes have won 8 of L/10 SU but just 5-5 ATS and the over has cashed on 8 of L/10. The visitor has covered 3 straight. Against common foes, Iowa (-2) scored a late 4th Q TD (4:43) LW vs Illinois to win 15-13, D held 116 yds below ssn avg. Neb (+6) played in a tough road game at Wisco going to OT falling short 24-17. As an fav by 3 or less Iowa is 15-7-1 ATS (2-1 TY). Both teams rank top 20 in our PDR but Iowa has the ST edge (#2 vs #83) so we will give the lean to the Hawkeyes!

OKLAHOMA by 20 over TCU - Before LY's outright upset by TCU, OU had won & covered 6 of the previous 7. TCU is avg'g 318 pass ypg the L/4 gms but here face thr #11 pass D that has allowed just 12 td's and has 18 int's and TCU QB Hoover has an 11-8 ratio but QB Morris took snaps late LW. OU QB Gabriel is hitting 70% (27-5) and has 337 rush (4.1, 11 td) but left LW with head inj (check status) and true frosh QB Arnold came on in relief. However TCU did allow 317 pass to Texas 2 wks ago. OU's run gm has also picked up, avg'g 196 (5.0) the L/4 gms & overall TCU's D has all'd 201 rush ypg (4.4) the L/4. OU also has the edge on ST (#13/#95) & have played the tougher sked (#23/#58). TCU does need a win for a bowl but OU is +192 ypg/+32 ppg at home and we like OU by nearly 3 tds.

Utah St by 3 over NEW MEXICO - USU has won and covered the L/6 meetings vs NMex. NMex is off a 25-17 upset at Fresno (4★ LP winner on NMex!) while USU lost 45-10 vs Boise & now need a

win for a bowl. NMex has the #131 pass D and the Aggies avg 254 pass ypg (60%) in MW play and QB Legas is hitting 65% (19-8). However NMex just put up 528 yds LW incl 345 rush (6.8) and here face a USU run D that is allowing 227 (5.1) the L/4 gms. Against 4 common MW foes USU is +14 ypg while NMex is +22 ypg! While we have the Aggies winning, NMex is off a big win and feeling confident and will keep this game within one score.

Missouri by 4 over ARKANSAS - Ark is 7-2 SU/8-1 ATS in this series and the underdog is 6-3 ATS in SEC meetings. The Hogs are staying home for bowl season but did beat FIU 44-20 (-29). Mizzou barely escaped FL, with a last second fg. The last time Ark was at home vs an SEC foe they were embarrassed by Auburn. We can't imagine a poor performance like that again and it's possibly KJ Jefferson's last home game. HC Pittman has been retained for next year. Mizzou just needs to win but Ark would love to play spoiler and ruin the Tigers chance at a NY6 bowl. We think the Hogs put forth A+ effort vs their rival and keep this much closer than expected.

TEXAS by 20 over Texas Tech - These in-state rivals meet for 1 final time as conf foes. Tex is out for revenge here after TT upset them LY. Texas is allowing 317 pass ypg the L/3 gms but TT is putting up just 219 pass ypg (60%) in B12 play. Texas does have a strong pass D (#36) and their run D is holding teams to just 56 ypg (2.1) the L/4 gms. Tex QB Ewers is hitting 68% (598 yds, 3-1 ratio) since returning from inj and they should be able to run on TT despite losing top RB Brooks, as TT allowed 238 rush (6.0) LW. Against 6 common B12 foes Texas is +130 ypg while TT is just +8 ypg. Texas is playing for a spot in the B12 title game while TT got their 6th win last week so there is less motivation for them here and we see the Horns getting the win here by nearly 3 tds'.

↑ Penn St by 28 over Michigan St - Detroit. Series is tied 18-18-1 & this is the 1st natural site matchup but is close to home for the Spartans. The HT has won 6 of L/8, PSU are 1-3 ATS at MSU. MSU have failed to cover 2 of L/5 but LW at Indy (+3) scored w/ 1:19 left to win 24-21. PSU vs unranked foes are now 8-1 ATS & vs Rutgers (-20) QB Allar exited game in 3rd Q but were still +93 net yds. Against 6 common foes PSU is +13 ppg & +67 ypg & while MSU is -19 ppg & -104 ypg in those matchups. We lean with the Nittany Lions to win big here as MSU is looking forward to next ssn.

OREGON by 21 over Oregon St - This appears to be the final "Civil War" for quite some time as the Beavers head into Eugene after seeing their 9-gm home winning streak snapped LW against undefeated UW who took advantage of 3 OSU TO's in a 22-20 victory (OSU 22-14 FD & 317-272 yd edges). The Ducks meanwhile are on the verge of reaching their 4th P12 Title gm in the L5Y after picking up a 36 pt road win at ASU (QB Nix 24-29-404-6-0). UO is 12-3 SU (8-7 ATS) in this series although they did suffer a 4 pt (-3) defeat LY at Reser as OSU overcame a 31-10 2H deficit with 3 TD's in a span of 5:13 in the 4Q (Ducks 26-19 FD & 470-328 yd edges, +3 TO's). The HT has won 4 straight while covering the L/3. With the Ducks also 8-3 ATS as a HF, they get the lean in this one.

Memphis by 8 over TEMPLE - The home team has won the L6 mtgs and Temple is 7-1 ATS in the series though Memphis did cover last year. The Tigers had their AAC bubble burst LW in their 38-34 (+9) loss to SMU. Memphis is actually -4 ypg vs the AAC now but Temple is -113. The Owls are only -17 ypg at home, beating Navy by 14 and outgained Utsa in a 15 pt loss. Memphis is 2-6 as an AAC AF and laying double-digits we will give a slight lean to the underdog.

SATURDAY NOVEMBER 25th

Wisconsin by 3 over MINNESOTA - A double revenge game for Wisky as they were upset the L/2 gms, prior to those losses they won 17 of L/20. LW UW beat Neb 24-17 (-6). RB Allen returned with 22-62 & a pair of TDs. The Gophers have covered 4 of L5 incl 3 upsets in series but TY they're 1-3 ATS as a dog incl LW at OSU (+27'), put up a ssn low 159yds on offense. Both teams are a combined (1-5) ATS L/3 wks. Minn has played the #11 schedule & Wisky #50. Wisky 22-13 as a B10 away fav so we will lean with them laying under a FG here.

SYRACUSE by 3 over Wake Forest - WF has won the last 3 meetings. The Demon Deacons are staying home for bowl season for the first time since '15 and come in having lost 4 straight. They've also lost their last seven road games vs Power 5 teams by 13 ppg. Cuse stuck with their Wildcat strategy last week with less success. QB Villari completed all 14 passes but only for 59 yards. They only trailed 24-22 until they gave up a td w/2:22 left to lose by 9 and after 8 years, HC Babers was finally let go. Cuse needs to a win to get bowl eligible. With their lack of a passing game, getting an early lead is paramount and WF hasn't had the lead at half in any game since week 2. Cuse is 7-3-1 ATS in the Dome s/21 and should get a win here as a small favorite.

MICHIGAN by 2 over Ohio St - 3rd straight year these teams enter "The Game" with a B10 East champ on the line. Mich has won back-to-back meetings for the 1st time s/99-'00, OSU had won 15 of 16 prior. Teams ranked #1 & #2 in def rank, #16 & #12 off rank but Mich has the ST edge #11 vs #30. This will be the 1st time s/14 OSU is an AD (MSU +4,49-37). The over has hit in 9 straight, with an average of 70 ppg (avg total just 53). LW OSU (-27') handled Minn 37-3, while Mich (-18') escaped on the road 31-24 at MD. TY OSU is on a 7-0-2 ATS run & Mich 5-2-1 ATS in B10 play, Mich is w/o their HC Harbaugh so we will lean with the Bucks to keep it close.

Georgia by 21 over GEORGIA TECH - UGA is 18-3 SU/14-6-1 ATS in this series and the visitor is 19-3-1 ATS. Last year UGA was off a physical win over KY and had the SEC Title gm on deck. UGA only led GT 10-7 and was actually outgained in the 1st half LY but pulled away for a 37-14 win (-36). Same situation again but UGA is off a 38-10 win at Tenn instead. After giving up a 75 yd td run on the first play UGA held GT to 202 yds the rest of the gm. GT is back in their preferred role as the underdog under Brent Key. The Jackets got bowl eligible by beating Cuse LW. UGA has battled injuries all year and are in a flat spot. GT is 11-5 as a dog the L2Y and with no pressure they will put up a good fight so our lean is cut off at 3 tds'.

Kansas by 10 over CINCINNATI - Teams have only met 2 times & the last mtg was in 1997. Cincy is off a 42-21 loss at WVU LW (4★ LP winner on WVU!) where they allowed 634 yds incl 424 rush (9.2!). KU is off a close loss to their in-state rival but should get QB Bean back TW after walk-on QB Ballard started again LW. KU has been relying on their run game TY and have topped 200 yds in 3 of the L/4 gms led by RB's Neal (1103, 6.4, 13 td) & Hishaw (574, 5.2) and the L/4 gms Cincy's run D is allowing 277 ypg (7.4). KU has the edge on offense (#32/#70), defense (#39/#78) and ST (#73/#104) and have played the tougher sked (#24/#55). Cincy is just 2-5-1 ATS in B12 play TY and we like the Jayhawks to close out the reg season with a win by DD's.

UCF by 21 over Houston - Former AAC foes now meet as B12 foes. They haven't met since 2020 and the home team has failed to cover 7 in a row. UCF's rush attack has been their strength TY, avg'g 210 ypg (5.4) but QB Plumlee is also hitting 61% and here faces the #108 pass D. The L/4 gms UH is -111 ypg/-16 ppg while UCF is +62 ypg/+8 ppg in B12 play and against 6 common B12 foes UCF is +24 ypg/+3 ppg while UH is -85 ypg/-14 ppg. UCF is looking for their 6th win & a trip to a bowl, while UH cannot make a bowl and are avg'g just 302 ypg on offense the L/4 gms. With UCF's home crowd behind them, we like the Knights here by 3 tds'.

Florida St by 3 over FLORIDA - The favorite in this series is 18-5 ATS but last year Florida was +10 and only lost 45-38 in Tallahassee. FSU QB Travis suffered a serious injury but this won't be the first time their backup, Tate Rodemaker has had to save the day. LY vs Louisville Rodemaker came in and threw 2 4Q td's, leading the 'Noles to a 35-31 win. FL has one more chance to get bowl eligible after nearly knocking off Missouri last week. The Gators also lost their QB, Graham Mertz to injury with rR Max Brown coming in late and made some nice plays, leading a td and fg drive. FL has play'd the tougher sked (#26 vs #63) and is at home while Rodemaker will make his first career road start and the opening 6' line has us leaning with the dog.

DUKE by 3 over Pittsburgh - The underdog is 7-2 ATS in this series but Duke is the favorite and they have lost the last 7 mtgs. Pitt was favored by 3 last week at home vs BC and only led 17-16 but got a 66 yd td run with 4:29 left. Duke was once 4-0 but they've completely fallen apart, losing 5 of their last 7 including a 30-27 loss at UVA last week. True frosh QB Lofitis did throw for 278 but their defense has had their 2 worst performances in the L2W, giving up 537 at NCAR and 448 at UVA. Pitt's Soph QB Yarnell looked more stable and less TO prone than their last 2 QB's. Pitt is 0-5 SU/ATS away from home while Duke is 5-1 SU at home so won't call for the upset but we do think Pitt keeps it close.

Virginia Tech by 10 over VIRGINIA - VT has won 17 of the L18 mtgs in the Commonwealth Cup but this game didn't get played last year so both coach's are meeting in this rivalry for the first time. VT still needs a win to get bowl eligible after losing LW 35-28 (-2) vs NCST. The Hokies fell behind 14-0 1Q and 35-14 4Q before scoring 2 late tds. UVA started 0-5 but has won 3 of their L6 with close losses at Miami & Louisville. VT is +92 ypg in ACC play while UVA is -16 though the Cavaliers have played the tougher sked (#8 vs #35). All of VT's wins have come by 17 points or more while UVA does have lopsided losses to Tenn, MD and GT.

Clemson by 10 over SOUTH CAROLINA - This is a huge revenge game for Clemson after they lost at home 31-30 LY as 14 pt chalk. Home team is 0-5 ATS in this series. Clemson has won their L4 gms after beating N.Carolina 31-20 (-7). SC lost to that same Tar Heels team by 14 way back in week 1. Clemson is +124 ypg against our #27 sked while SC is -22 ypg but against our #9 sked. This is SC's 4th straight home game after beating KY 17-14 (-2) though SC only put up 257 yds and now they face Clemson's D that allows just 21 ppg and 289 ypg. The Tigers have covered their L4 in Columbia (avg MOV 23.5 ppg) and we think Clemson ends the season on a 4 game win streak.

North Carolina by 7 over NC STATE - The visitor in this series is 7-3 SU/8-2 ATS but the dog is 18-6 ATS with 14 outright upsets! NC had their ACC Title game hopes busted last week in their 31-20 loss to Clemson. The Tar Heels have put up the most yards each of their L4 opponents have allowed but their D has reverted to last year's form, allowing 37 ppg and 480 ypg in their L5 vs FBS foes. NCST has won & covered 4 straight, including the L2 with Brennan Armstrong as QB. LW they led VTech 35-14 (+2) 4Q before allowing 2 late tds. The 'Pack's 408 yards was their most vs an FBS foe this ssn. NC is +119 ypg vs our #62 sked while NCSt is only +10 ypg vs our #52 sked. We still don't have a lot of faith in Armstrong and will side with the Tar Heels.

RUTGERS by 1 over Maryland - Both teams joined the B10 in 2014 & since then Maryland is 6-3 SU/ATS. In those 3 wins Rutgers have upset the Terrapins & the SU winner has covered L/11. MD has outgained RU in all but one matchup, avg YPG +142. TY both teams are bowl eligible. Rut is 4-1-1 ATS TY off is avg 355 ypg & all'g 250 ypg at home (off 241, D 355 on road). LW at Penn St (+20) lost 27-6 but did hold them to 88 yds passing. MD in B10 play is 4-4 ATS, incl LW vs Mich(+18), had 3 drives to go ahead but went punt, int & saf to fall 31-24. Rut is 4-1-1 ATS at home so we will give them the lean laying under a FG here.

APPALACHIAN ST by 12 over Georgia Southern - Deeper Than Hate rivalry. GS dropped their 3rd straight gm LW while App upset JMU on the road in OT. After starting 3-4 TY App has now won 4 straight (3-1 ATS) and the L4 gms are +108 ypg/+16 ppg while GS is -12 ypg/-3 ppg the L4. App still only has the #124 pass D but over the L4 gms GS's pass attack has dipped to putting up 268 ypg (57%). App's D has improved the L/3 gms, allowing just 284 ypg/15 ppg. App is facing a GS team with the #93 pass D and QB Aguilar is hitting 64% (26-7). While GS has covered 5 straight & pulled 3 outright upsets vs App, these tms are headed in opposite directions & we like App by DD's.

PURDUE by 3 over Indiana - First met on the gridiron in 1891 & play for the Old Oaken Bucket. Purdue is 4-2 SU & 6-0 ATS but have been outgained in 4 of those matchups. Both teams are not bowl eligible. The Hoosiers did hold MSU to 85 yds below their ssn avg but gave up late TD to lose 24-21. IU in their L2 road games have covered & have had chance to win in 4th Q but dropped both those gms. Purdue went w/out QB Card at NW (PK) LW they were +114 nets yds but did fall 23-15. Purdue at home is just 2-4 SU/ATS so we give the lean to the Hoosiers to keep it close.

EAST CAROLINA by 7 over Tulsa - EC has lost the L/3 mtgs and Tulsa has covered 5 of the L/6 mtgs but the Pirates are favored by 3 here. EC has lost 6 of their L/7 including LW at Navy 10-0 (+2) where they had just 189 yds. Tulsa has lost 6 straight though their last 3 have all come by a td or less. EC has a big edge on D, allowing 331 ypg and holding foes 27 ypg below their avg. We will take the Pirates at home but couldn't imagine putting a play on this game.

USF by 3 over Charlotte - First mtg. USF needs a win to reach a bowl after getting crushed 49-21 at UTSA last week. The Bulls have been unpredictable, with a high powered offense, 33 ppg, 479

ypg in AAC play but allow 43 ppg and 518 ypg in AAC play! CLT had just 7 pts and 158 yds LW vs Rice. The 49ers did win their L/2 road games at EC and Tulsa and are 5-0 ATS on the road (-14 ypg). USF only beat Temple by 4 and lost to FAU by 42 at home. We will go with the better offense to win the game but not by much.

Miami, OH by 3 over BALL ST - Since '17, the winner takes home the Red Bird Rivalry Trophy, with Miami going 5-1 SU & 4-2 ATS since incl 3 straight wins but failed to cover LY as a 2 pt HF. LTH had 7 lead changes with Miami (+4) scoring GW td & 2 pt conv w/11:54 left for a 24-17 win, While Ball St is locked into a losing season HC Neu has them playing with pride & they have won 3 of L/4 & have covered L/5 Since losing the ssn opener Miami is 9-1 SU & ATS. They have been winning with D, not allowing a MAC foe over 21 pts with 2 shutouts. Their only loss was to Toledo, who they have a rematch with in the MAC title gm on deck & will want to remain healthy. So take the pts.

OLD DOMINION by 7 over Georgia St - In their only prior mtg as SBC foes LY, GST was +130 yds and won 31-17. After starting the ssn 6-1 SU/5-2 ATS GST has now dropped 4 in a row SU/ATS and over their L4 games are -203 ypg/-29 ppg. ODU picked up a big win LW at GSThm and now need one more win for a bowl. While ODU is allowing 433 ypg their L4, GST's offense has dipped to 284 ypg/14 ppg the L/3 gms while their defense is giving up 528 ypg/46 ppg over their L4 gms. GST also struggles vs the pass (#133, 67%, 27-9 ratio allowed). Against 6 common SBC foes ODU is just -39 ypg and GST is -92 ypg and we like ODU to get their 6th win here!

Northern Illinois by 21 over KENT ST - Huskies are 11-1 SU & 8-4 ATS vs Flashes s/02. Last met in '21 MAC Championship. NIU (+4) won 41-23 getting revenge for a 52-47 reg ssn loss. NIU after back-to-back losses by a comb 9 pts due to 3 TO's in each, pulled a 24-0 win over WM with 0 TO's to save their bowl hopes. Needing a win here, NIU should be just as determined here. Kent St was an almost entirely new team TY with just 4 ret starters & a new HC, They are 0-10 SU & 1-8-1 ATS vs FBS foes losing by an avg 27 ppg & have just 8 take-aways all ssn. Look for the Huskies to take care of business in what will likely be an almost empty stadium.

Middle Tennessee by 4 over SAM HOUSTON - MT is trying to end TY on a 3 game win streak after they beat FIU and UTEP the L/2 wks. MT is -3 ypg in CUSA play while SH is -52 ypg in CUSA play. The Bearkats did manage to cover LW at WKU, only losing 28-23 (+11). The Bearkats are now on a 16-5 ATS run as underdogs including 5-3 ATS this year but most of those were as double-digit dogs and here they are only +4. We think MT is the better team but our lean is right at the line.

TENNESSEE by 35 over Vanderbilt - Vandy is 0-5 ATS and -129 ypg on the road this year. The Vols didn't take mercy on Vandy last year in a 56-0 win and we expect more of the same. The Vols are off 2 straight losses to Mizou and UGA, playing their final home game. Vandy is -196 ypg in SEC play. They are off a bye and the week prior lost at South Carolina 47-6 (+13). Tenn's offense has struggled the last two weeks but they put up 59 pts and 750 yds vs UConn a few weeks. Tenn's inj's at WR have us a little concerned and they may play a young cast in the 2H to get ready for next year but we can't possibly back Vandy who is 1-10 ATS this year.

RICE by 7 over Fau - Two former CUSA foes meet in AAC play. JT Daniels missed last week but Rice still beat CLT 28-7 (-3) so a win here and they are bowl eligible for the first time under HC Bloomgren. FAU had just 234 yds and trailed Tulane 24-0 until a 4Q td. Rice is -44 ypg vs AAC foes while FAU is -49. Rice is -2 ypg at home and had close losses to both Tulane by 2 and SMU by 5. FAU has scored just 15 points in their last 2 games with only 406 yards combined. This game is huge for Rice and we think they get the win by a touchdown.

MARSHALL by 1 over Arkansas St - First meeting. Ark St is going to a bowl for the 1st time s/'19 after their 77-31 win vs TXSt LW despite being -52 yds & -9 FD's as Ark St was +4 TO's & had two pick-6's, a fumble return td and a KR td. MU needs a win here for a bowl as they fell to SAIA 28-0 LW and now are just 1-6 SU/ATS in SBC play. Over the L/5 gms MU's offense is avg'g just 253 ypg/12 ppg. MU is -105 ypg vs SBC foes while Ark St is -58 ypg, but over their L/4 gms Ark St is actually +4 ypg while MU is -128 ypg. Ark St's offense is avg'g 418 ypg/41 ppg the L/4 gms led by QB Raynor & RB Cross. We like MU to win, but Ark St will keep this gm close.

UTAH by 31 over Colorado - The Buffs will be sitting at home for bowl ssn following a 5th straight loss LW in Pullman where they trailed 42-7 at HT in an eventual 42 pt defeat (WSU 447-255 yd edge). The Utes on the other hand saw their aspirations of reaching DD wins for the 4th time in 5 yrs (3-2 in '20) end LW in Tucson with the Wildcats grabbing an easy 42-18 victory. Utah has won 12 of the past 14 in this series although they're just 6-6 ATS s/'11. LY they put up 629 yds in a 63-21 (-29') rout in Boulder. The Utes have also gone 9-2 ATS as a HF the L2Y which doesn't bode well for a Buffs squad that's failed to cover 7 of their L/8 P12 AG's (CU QB Sanders ? after inj LW).

COASTAL CAROLINA +9' over James Madison

COASTAL CAROLINA (+) over James Madison - These tms met in LY's ssn finale & JMU won big 47-7 (+317 yds/+14 FD). JMU had their unbeaten ssn end LW in OT with a loss to App St 26-23 while CC had a tough non-conf gm vs Army that they lost 28-21. While CC's offense is still avg'g 404 ypg w/o QB the L/4 gms, their D has been strong as well, all'g just 318 ypg the L/4 gms. JMU is throwing for 356 (73%) the L/4 gms but CC is giving up just 115 pass ypg (52%) over their L/4. JMU could have a bubble burst here & CC needs a win to reach the SBC title game, so we'll take CC to win outright as they are 23-3 SU at home since 2020!

Arizona by 4 over ARIZONA ST - The Wildcats extended their winning streak to 5 straight LW at home vs Utah in surprising blowout fashion (led 28-0 in 2Q) while ASU had no answer for the Ducks in their own home defeat (outgained 603-316 in 36 pt loss). The Sun Devils are 6-2 SU (5-3 ATS) in recent battles with their rival although they did drop a 38-35 (+4) meeting a year ago on the road despite a 537-480 yd edge (ASU -3 TO's). The Wildcats and Sun Devils have combined for an impressive 12-4 ATS mark in P12 play on the year. While we could make a case for both squads in this one, we'll back the most recent trend in this series with the HT covering 6 of the past 9.

UNLV by 3 over San Jose St - SJSt has won and covered 8 of the L/10 mtgs vs UNLV. The Rebels still need a win to reach the MW title game, but are off a 31-27 upset at AF where QB Maiava threw for 339 yds. SJSt has won 5 SU in a row to get back into the MW race but failed to cover LW as our 5★ GOY. It is tough to go against either team in this spot as UNLV is 10-1 ATS on the season and are +83 ypg/+15 ppg in MW play while SJSt is +84 ypg/+12 ppg. SJSt is only allowing 268 ypg the L/4 gms incl just 106 rush (3.2) while UNLV is allowing just 344 ypg the L/4. We feel like these tms are evenly matched and will side with the home tm by a fg.

UCLA by 5 over California - Following a surprising 38-20 (+5') road upset LW against the Trojans where they held USC to just 3 rushing yards, the Bruins welcome a Cal squad that's still alive for a bowl berth after their 12 pt road victory in Palo Alto where they finished with solid FD (29-12) and yard (455-289) edges. These 2 have plyd every year since 1933. The Bruins are on an 8-2 SU run while the spread has been split at 5 apiece in that span. LY UCLA (-10') escaped Berkeley with a 35-28 victory in a contest that featured 7 lead changes. Cal has played our all of the toughest P12 teams (#3 toughest sked) while UCLA has missed UW & Oregon (#62 sked). Although the HT is on a 10-3 ATS run incl 3 straight covers, it's also worth mentioning that the Bears are 13-6 ATS as an AD and could make a bowl for the 1st time s/19.

WASHINGTON by 10 over Washington St - The Cougs kept their slim bowl hopes alive after a 56-14 (-4') win over the Buffs last Fri (2 Def TD & 98 yd KR TD, WSU 22-15 FD & 447-255 yd edges). They now head into Seattle to take on a UW squad that remained unbeaten LW in Corvallis despite being held to a ssn-low 272 yds (avg 504 ypg prior). The Huskies have won 8 of the past 9 in the series (7-2 ATS) although they did suffer a 40-13 (+1) loss the last time they met here in '21 with WSU finishing with a 454-200 yd edge. After going 13-4-1 ATS vs the P12 the prior 2 yrs, WSU has gone just 2-6 ATS in conf matchups TY. Despite that mark, we expect the visitor to stay within the line in the "Apple Cup" as the Huskies have failed to cover 3 straight as a HF, have unbeaten pressure as well as a potential P12 title meeting with the high-flying Ducks on deck.

Wku by 14 over FIU - WKU is 4-0 SU/3-0-1 ATS in this series. Last year the "Toppers absolutely demolished FIU 73-0 with a 690-185 yd edge. WKU only beat Sam Houston 28-23 LW but did get their 6th win. FIU has lost 3 straight by 25, 34 & 24 though they did manage to cover LW at Ark. FIU is -19 ppg & -149 ypg in CUSA play while WKU is +2 ppg & +6 ypg in CUSA play. It's been a disappointing season for WKU but a win here clinches a winning record and all of FIU's recent losses have been by 13 points or more.

SAN DIEGO ST by 1 over Fresno St - While Fresno has covered 7 of the L/8 vs SDSt, the Aztecs are playing their final game under HC Hoke here and Fresno just lost outright LW at home to NMex as a 23-pt favorite (4★ LP winner on NMex!) and are out of the hunt for the MW title. Despite SDSt being just 3-8 SU and Fresno 8-3 SU, the Aztecs are -18 ypg vs 4 common MW foes while Fresno is -29 ypg. While SDSt is avg'g just 290 ypg/14 ppg the L/4 gms, Fresno's D is allowing 475 ypg and are -152 ypg overall the L/4 gms while SDSt is just -66 ypg over the L/4 gms. SDSt will play inspired football for Hoke & we like them to win outright and Fresno is just 1-6 ATS vs MW foes.

South Alabama by 10 over TEXAS ST - Teams have traded wins as SBC foes and the home team is actually 8-0 SU/6-2 ATS in the series. SALA picked up their 6th win LW vs Marshall 28-0 while TXSt lost at Ark ST despite being +52 yds as they were -4 TO's and gave up two pick 6's, a fumble ret td & a KR td. SALA does have the massive edge on defense (#20/#122) as they are all'g 290 ypg in SBC play & overall are holding foes to 80 ypg under their avg (#13). TXSt threw for 366 yds LW but had costly int's & now face a better SALA pass D that allows just 166 ypg (56%) in SBC play. We like the road team to finally get a win in the series & side with SALA by DD's.

Alabama by 20 over AUBURN - Hugh Freeze is the only active SEC HC with multiple wins over Nick Saban but he's not likely to get one here against a Bama squad that is on a roll. An Auburn win would be even more shocking considering they just lost to New Mexico St 31-10 (-26) and was outgained 414-213! The Tide have won 8 straight including 14 pt wins over Tennessee, LSU & Ole Miss. Bama has also covered 4 straight including a 28 pt win at Kentucky. Bama is fresh and full of confidence. Saban won't want to ruin that with a lackluster performance before the SEC Title game so we expect a dominant win but the value has been lost by Auburn's choke job last week.

OKLAHOMA ST by 24 over Byu - Only have met twice before and not since 1976 in the Tangerine Bowl! Okla St stayed in the hunt for the B12 title gm with a win at Houston, while BYU only lost by 7 at home to Okla (+22 yds!). BYU struggles to stop the run (206, 5.4 vs B12 foes) and Okla St avg's 184 (5.4) in B12 play led by RB Gordon (1413, 6.7, 15 td). BYU struggles on the road (-164 ypg/-19 ppg) and at home in B12 play Okla St is +60 ypg/+13 ppg and are 4-0 SU/ATS but 3 of those wins were as a dog. Agsinst 5 common B12 foes BYU is -116 ypg while Okla St is +41 ypg. With the B12 title gm in sight we see Okla St putting their foot on the gas & winning big here.

West Virginia by 14 over BAYLOR - WVU has covered 4 of the L/5 games against Baylor and LY WVU pulled the outright upset at home. Baylor is just 3-8 SU/ATS on the season while WVU has covered 3 of the L/4 gms and could have their first 8-win reg ssn since 2016. Against B12 foes this season Baylor has allowed 441 ypg/37 ppg and here face a WVU offense avg'g 495 ypg/35 ppg the L/4 gms incl rushing for 306 ypg (6.6) over that stretch and WVU just ran for 424 (9.2) LW led by RB's Donaldson and White, plus QB Greene has 605 rush (6.2) TY. Baylor is just 1-6 ATS at home this season and we like the more motivated Mauntaineers to win here by 2 td's.

NORTH TEXAS by 10 over Uab - UAB is 5-1 SU/6-0 ATS in this series but this is the first meeting between 1st year HC's Morris and Dilfer. NT looks to end the season on a 2 game win streak after beating Tulsa 35-28 (-2). The Mean Green's previous 4 losses were to the top 4 teams in the AAC

and 3 of those losses were by 8 points or less. UAB beat Temple 34-24 (-7) but they've lost all 5 road games this year by 20 ppg (-57 ypg). Both defenses have struggled so this could be a high scoring game. QB Rogers has a 26-4 ratio and we will take the home team who has won their L/3 on Senior Day.

ILLINOIS by 3 over Northwestern - 117th meeting for the Land of Lincoln Trophy. Illionis have won SU/ATS L/2 mtgs but before that NW controlled the series winning 8 of 9 & 6-3 ATS. The Illini have failed to cover at home & 3-8 ats W TY, LW at Iowa (+2') offense had a ssn low 280 yds but had the lead late in 4th giving up a TD w/ 4:43 to go losing 15-13. The Cats are 7-4 ATS TY & beat Purdue (PK) 23-15 LW to become bowl eligible! NW has the Def edge (#35 vs #64) but Illinois has the off edge (#43 vs #93) , we will lean the Cats D to get the cover here.

KANSAS ST by 14 over Iowa St - Rivalry dubbed "Farmageddon" and they will meet here for the 107th time. More recently KSt is 6-3 SU but just 2-7 ATS vs ISU. KSt still has a shot to reach the B12 title game while ISU has clinched a bowl but cannot make the B12 title gm. ISU is holding B12 foes to just 367 ypg and 130 rush ypg (3.9) but KSt's defense is holding tms to 56 ypg under their avg (#20). KSt at home in B12 play is avg'g 492 ypg and in those 4 B12 home games are +180 ypg/+32 ppg. KSt is on an 11-2 ATS run at home the L/2Y incl going 6-0 ATS TY and with the Wildcats needing a win to keep their B12 title hopes alive, we like them here by 2 td's.

LSU by 17 over Texas A&M - LSU is out for revenge after losing 38-23 (-10) last year. HC Kelly is clearly making every effort to let Jayden Daniels build stats for his Heisman Campaign. Last week LSU was tied 14-14 2Q vs Georgia St then ran away with the next 42 points. Daniels threw for 413 yards and had 8 total td's. He now has a 36-4 ratio, 11.8 ypa and leads LSU in rushing with 1,104 (8.2). The Tigers have put up the most yards all but 1 of their foes have allowed this season! In their first game after firing HC Fisher, A&M trailed Abilene Christian 7-0 LW after a Pick-6 but ultimately won by 28. QB Henderson has won both of his starts but isn't going to keep up with Daniels and Brian Kelly will want an emphatic win over a rival on Senior Day.

LOUISIANA by 6 over Ulm - Battle on the Bayou. LA has won 12 of the L/15 SU in the series. While ULM cannot make a bowl, they can play the role of spoiler here as LA still needs a win to reach a bowl. LA has dropped their L/3 games incl getting upset vs Ark St and SMiss and the Cajuns offense is avg'g just 353 ypg the L/4 games. Against 5 common SBC foes LA is -75 ypg while ULM is -147 ypg & ULM has faced the tougher sked (#73/#108). The visiting team in this series is on a remarkable 20-3-1 ATS and with ULM getting nearly 2 td's our lean is solidly with them here!

Troy by 17 over SOUTHERN MISS - Since 2016 Troy is 3-1 SU/ATS against SMiss. SMiss is avg'g 401 ypg vs SBC foes, but against a strong SALA D only put up 149 and here face a Troy D holding foes to 88 ypg under their avg (#8) and overall in SBC play are giving up just 305 ypg/12 ppg. Against 5 common SBC foes Troy is +114 ypg while SMiss is -39 ypg. Troy has a trip to the SBC title game locked up so may try to rest some players 2H if they are up big. Still, Troy is the much more dominant team here & are 6-1 ATS vs the SBC but this could be a look-ahead spot for them.

Liberty by 14 over UTEP - The Flames have the CUSA Title game vs NMSt on deck. Liberty was no match for UMass last week in their 49-25 (-27') win. UTEP suffered another loss where they had the yardage edge, falling at Middle Tenn by 4 but they had a 453-427 yd edge. The Miners are actually +35 ypg vs CUSA foes on the season. Last year UTEP should have upset UTSA the week prior to the CUSA Title game (led 31-14 3Q). We think they keep it closer than expected this time against Liberty as well.

Jacksonville St by 4 over NEW MEXICO ST - New Mexico St is off a monumental 31-10 upset over Auburn as 26 pt dogs and the Aggies have now covered 7 straight. QB Pavia's status was in doubt but he played and threw 3 td passes. JSU is 8-3 this year and are off a 56-17 (-9') beat down over LA Tech (4 straight covers). The Gamecocks nearly had an SEC upset of their own at South Carolina a few weeks ago. If JSU was eligible for the postseason, this game would decide who plays in the CUSA Title game but their waiver was denied last week so they will be hungry to prove they are the better team and this is a giant flat spot for NMSt off their win with the conference title on deck. JSU is +10 ppg and +34 ypg vs CUSA foes while NMSt is +7 ppg and only +3 ypg vs CUSA foes. We will take the Gamecocks to prove their point!

Wyoming by 17 over NEVADA - WY has won and covered 3 of the L/4 gms but have not met since 2020. WY is off a 42-9 win vs Haw where they threw for over 300 yds for the first time since 2020 while Nev lost at Colo St 30-20. WY QB Peasley could have another big pass day here vs the #123 pass D that is allowing 262 pass ypg (65%). Nev's run D also allows 177 ypg (5.0) vs MW foes and WY RB Waylee (785, 5.9) could have a big day & QB Peasley is also a threat to run (307, 3.3). Nev's offense avg's just 309 ypg and gets held to 87 ypg under what their foes typically allow (#128) while WY's D is holding tms to 28 ypg under their avg. We like WY by over 2 td's here.

Colorado St by 3 over HAWAII - CSU has failed to cover their L/3 meetings vs Haw. The Rams still need one more win to reach a bowl, while Haw cannot reach a bowl. Haw comes in with the #119 ranked pass D (61%, 22-6) and the Rams avg 306 ypg (62%) led by QB Millen and they have a talented receiver room. CSU has also ran the ball better of late (183 and 169 the L/2 gms) and UH allows 198 (4.7) vs MW foes. However, UH is just -16 ypg at home while CSU is -94 ypg on the road and vs 5 common MW foes CSU is +22 ypg while UH is just -6 ypg. We like the Rams to get the win but UH should keep this close.

Connecticut by 1 over UMASS - Former 1-AA conf rivals, have met 5 times as FBS foes s/2012, with the Home Team & UConn being 3-2 SU & ATS. Outright winner has covered all 5 with Favorite going 4-1. LY was 10-10 2Q before Huskies scored the final 17 to cover as a 15' pt HF. Both are 5-6 ATS with a combined 3 FBS wins, in a toss-up game like this take the pts if you must.

4★ MINNESOTA over Chicago - MNF - The Vikings are a HF for just the 2nd time TY (Wk 1 vs TB) following a road trip to "Mile High" that saw them tripped up by a point (4★ Newsletter Winner on MIN!) despite 19-13 FD and 385-295 yd edges (DEN +3 TO's). The Bears meanwhile blew a DD 4Q lead LW in Ford Field as the Lions would get a GW 1-yd TD run with :31 left. These 2 met in Soldier Field back in mid-Oct with the Vikings (-3) collecting a 19-13 victory despite CHI finishing with a 275-220 yd edge (MIN +2 TO's). With the Vikings covering 6 straight heading in and the Bears on just a 3-12 ATS run inside the NFC North, it may be a long night for a visitor that's now lost 5 straight (1-4 ATS) in this series with a 10 pt avg margin of defeat. **FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 13**

3★ LA Rams over ARIZONA - Following a 1 pt home victory against SEA where they overcame a 16-7 deficit in the 4Q and hit a GW 22-yd FG with 1:34 left, the Rams head into the desert to take on a Cardinals squad that was tripped up LW in HOU with a late drive (trailing by 5) being stalled in Texans' territory (HOU 419-319 yd edge). In their mid-Oct meeting in LA, the Rams (-7) won for the 12th time in 14 tries (SU & ATS) with ARZ outgained 382-345 in the 17 pt defeat. With the Cardinals failing to cover 9 of the L/10 against NFC West foes and the Rams covering 6 of their L/9 DIV road contests, we'll give the visitor the TD edge in this one. **FORECAST: LA Rams by 7**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ HOUSTON over Jacksonville - The Texans picked up their 3rd straight victory LW at home against ARZ despite rookie QB Stroud throwing 3 int's in the ARZ RZ (HOU 419-319 yd edge). The Jags meanwhile bounced back from a 31 pt loss to SF with a 20 pt home win against the Titans where they finished with 24-12 FD and 389-235 yd edges. Dating back to LY, the Jags are 8-0 SU/ATS away from JAX with a 13 pt avg MOV. That might end here as the Texans have won 10 of the L/11 (8-3 ATS) against the Jags including a 37-17 (+7) road upset earlier TY where rookie QB Stroud threw for 280 yds and 2 TD's (HOU 11-5 ATS run vs DIV foes). **FORECAST: HOUSTON by 7**

OTHER PLAYS

DETROIT by 10 over Green Bay - Thursday - Following a 23-20 (+3) comeback home win LW against the Chargers where they got a GW 24-yd TD pass with 2:38 left (QB Love 27-40-322-2-0), the Packers head into DET to take on a Lions squad that's covered 17 of their L/21 matchups. In their meeting with CHI a week ago, DET needed to overcome a deficit of their own (trailed 26-14 in 4Q) with a GW 1-yd TD run with :31 left (Lions -3 TO's). The Lions have grabbed 4 straight victories (SU & ATS) against the Packers including a 34-20 (-2) win earlier TY in Lambeau where RB Montgomery rushed for 121 yds and 3 TD's. While GB is a solid 13-6 ATS as an AD, the Lions are 7-3 ATS as a HF while covering 11 of their L/12 inside of the NFC North.

DALLAS by 6 over Washington - Thursday - The Cowboys had no issue disposing of the Panthers LW in Charlotte as they finished with 23-13 FD and 311-187 yd edges in a 23 pt victory. They now return home where they've covered 11 of their L/15 inside of the NFC East. The Commanders (-9) suffered a 2nd loss TY against DIV rival NYG LW at home with a whopping 6-0 TO deficit (WAS 28-13 FD & 403-292 yd edges). The home squad collected wins in both meetings a year ago including a 25-10 (-3) victory by the Cowboys where bkp QB Rush (15-27-223-2-0) started for the inj'd Prescott (WAS 297-279 yd edge). Although DAL is an outstanding 14-5 ATS as a HF, laying more than a TD is too much in our opinion as WAS has gone 6-1-1 ATS as a dog while covering 5 of their L/6 AG's.

San Francisco at SEATTLE - Thursday - This marks the only HG in a 4-wk span as the Seahawks return to the "Pacific NW" following a 1 pt loss to the Rams with big trips to DAL and SF on deck. The 49ers have picked up 2 solid wins since their return from bye including a 27-14 victory LW at home against the Bucs where QB Purdy was flawless throwing for 333 yds and 3 TD's. The 49ers picked up 3 straight victories (SU & ATS) LY against the Seahawks including a 41-23 win in the WC Round where they finished with a 505-332 yd edge. While SF is also 8-0-1 ATS vs DIV foes, keep in mind that SEA is 11-3 ATS when getting points at home (QB Smith ? as of presstime). **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on Wednesday 11/22.**

Miami at NY JETS - Friday - Despite having commanding 21-12 FD and 422-296 yd edges LW at home in South Beach, the Dolphins (-14) needed some strong defense late in the 4Q to pick up a 7 pt victory over the Raiders. They now head up North to take on a Jets squad that was handed their 3rd consec loss LW in BUF where QB Wilson was benched in the 2H for #3 Boyle who didn't make much of an impact himself (Jets avg just 8 ppg & 8 TO's over L/3). In their trip to NY a year ago, the Dolphins (-3) saw their 4-gm series winning streak snapped in blowout fashion as the Jets had 5 rushing TD's in the 40-17 victory. While revenge will clearly be on MIA's mind and they've covered 8 of their L/10 overall against the AFC East, the Jets have beaten the Bills (+2) and Eagles (+6) outright inside their home venue TY while also covering as an 8 pt dog against the Chiefs. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after 11am EST on Friday.**

INDIANAPOLIS by 4 over Tampa Bay - The Colts are home chalk for the 1st time all ssn after a '22 campaign that saw them fail to cover 4 of 5 in that role. IND does come in following a bye while the Bucs are back on the road for a 2nd straight week (13 pt loss LW at SF, outgained 420-287). The Bucs have won the last 2 meetings in this series including a 38-31 (-3) victory in '21 thanks in part to 5 TO's by the Colts (IND 392-359 yd edge). While TB is 5-0 ATS as an AD overall, the well-rested Colts (14-3-1 ATS after a bye) will get the victory in this one.

NY GIANTS by 3 over New England - The Giants return home after a 3-gm road trip that saw them destroyed by the Raiders and Cowboys (outscored 79-23) along with a surprising 31-19 (+9) upset against the Commanders where they finished with a 6-0 TO edge (rookie QB DeVito 18-26-246-3-0). The Patriots meanwhile return from bye with questions at QB after Mac Jones was benched late in the 4Q for Bailey Zappe in their 10-6 loss to the Colts. While the Giants did pick up a pair of Super Bowl victories against the Patriots during the '07 and '11 seasons, NE has won the L/2 regular ssn matchups including 35-14 (-17) in '19 (Pats 27-10 FD & 427-213 yd edges, NYG 4 TO's!). The Patriots are however on just a 2-12 ATS run overall which includes an 0-4 SU/ATS mark against the NFC TY where they've been outscored by 19 ppg. With the Giants going a solid 6-2-1 ATS in their own non-conf battles, we'll reluctantly lean in their direction.

TENNESSEE by 7 over Carolina - The Titans return to Nashville (5 of L/7 gms at home) following a rough 3-gm road trip that saw them go 0-3 SU/ATS including a 20 pt loss in JAX where they were held to just 12 FD's and 235 yds. The Panthers meanwhile begin a 3-gm road trip after a 23 pt home defeat against the Cowboys where they were held to just 13 FD's and 187 yds. The Titans have dropped the past 2 meetings with the Panthers (SU & ATS) including a 30-20 (+3) defeat in Charlotte back in '19 (CAR led 17-0 at HT). While TEN hasn't won on the road since the middle of LY, they've been quite successful inside of their home venue TY with a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS mark (all as underdogs). With the Panthers going just 4-8 ATS as a NDIV AD, we're riding with the home squad.

Pittsburgh by 1 over CINCINNATI - The Steelers make their 2nd straight AFC North trip following a 3 pt loss in CLE where the Browns connected on a GW 34-yd FG with :02 remaining (PIT outgained for 10th consec gm to start the ssn!). The Bengals dropped a 2nd straight contest last Thur against the Ravens (BAL 405-272 yd edge) with QB Burrow being lost for the ssn with a wrist inj (bkp Browning 8-14-68-1-0, 40 rush in relief). In their home meeting a ssn ago, the Bengals (-7) scored the game-tying TD with :02 left before an eventual 23-20 loss in OT as the extra period expired (PIT GW 53-yd FG, CIN QB Burrow 4 int's!). Will the Steelers be able to take advantage of a DIV bkp QB after failing to a week ago?

ATLANTA by 4 over New Orleans - A battle of well-rested squads face-off in this one with the Falcons (4-1 ATS after a bye) taking on the Saints (0-4 ATS off a bye). The Saints have won 8 of the L/10 overall against the Falcons although they did fail to cover both contests a year ago including a 21-18 (-4) win late in the ssn. With a handful of starters in question for the visiting team in this one including QB Derek Carr (shldr/concussion), we expect the Falcons (6-2 ATS run in the NFC South) to grab the outright victory (NO 1-6-1 ATS vs DIV foes).

DENVER by 6 over Cleveland - The Broncos are on a 4-gm winning streak for the 1st time since '16 following a 21-20 comeback victory over the Vikings (GW 15-yd TD pass w/1:03 left). They now welcome a Browns squad that's won 3 straight of their own after a 13-10 home win over the Steelers (GW 34-yd FG w/:02 left) where rookie QB Thompson-Robinson (24-43-165-0-1, 20 rush yds) got the start after the ssn-ending loss of Deshaun Watson. Although the Broncos own a 24-7 all-time edge in this series, the Browns (-1) did pick up a 17-14 victory in their most recent matchup back in '21 (23-15 FD & 376-223 yd edges). With DEN needing some extra momentum with a 3-gm road trip on deck, we expect them to take advantage of DTR in this one as he makes his 1st career road start.

PHILADELPHIA by 8 over Buffalo - The Eagles are back at home on short rest following a MNF trip to Arrowhead. The Bills meanwhile ended a 6-gm ATS losing streak LW on the road against the Jets following the firing of their OC after their home loss to DEN (22-14 FD & 393-155 yd edges in 26 pt victory). After winning 4 straight against the Eagles from 1990-1999, the Bills have now dropped 4 of their L/5 in the series (SU & ATS) including a 31-13 home defeat in '19 where they were listed as 1 pt chalk (PHI 371-253 yd edge). While BUF is a solid 10-3-2 ATS as an AD heading in, injuries have taken a toll on both side of the ball throughout. We expect the Eagles to grab the win and cover in this one as they've gone 12-5 ATS as a HF the past 3 years.

Kansas City by 6 over LAS VEGAS - The Chiefs head into Allegiant Stadium on short rest after a Super Bowl rematch on MNF against the Eagles. The Raiders meanwhile return home following their 1st loss under interim HC Pierce (now 2-1 since taking over) where they were outFD'd (21-12) and outgained (422-296) in a 20-13 defeat against the Dolphins. While the Raiders have covered 7 of their past 9 HG's, keep in mind that one of those defeats came in LY's ssn finale with KC (-9) picking up a 31-13 victory (KC 14-2 SU/10-6 ATS in recent series history). Despite that recent history favoring the Chiefs, also keep in mind that they've failed to cover 7 of their L/10 inside of the DIV. With the Raiders going a polar opposite 7-3 ATS against the AFC West, we'll call for them to stay within the line prior to their bye.

Baltimore at LA CHARGERS - SNF - The Ravens head out West with some extra rest following a Thur night matchup against the Bengals where they finished with a 405-272 yd edge in a 2 TD victory. The Chargers meanwhile return to SoFi after a 3 pt loss in Lambeau (GB GW 24-yd TD pass w/2:38 left). BAL has won and covered the past 2 meetings against the Chargers including a 34-6 (-3) home rout in '21 where they finished with 27-14 FD and 327-208 yd edges. While the Ravens have struggled as away chalk recently with a 4-9 ATS mark, keep in mind that they can go all out in this West Coast trip with a bye on the horizon. **Call the office on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**
