The Browns and Texans meet in the postssn for the 1st time ever. CLE rattled off 4 consec victories (excluding finale when they rested starters) to earn the top WC spot. The Texans meanwhile picked up B2B wins to close out the year against DIV rivals TEN and IND to get here (JAX losing 5 of L/6 saw HOU win their DIV and earn the #4 seed). These 2 actually met less than a month ago with the Browns (-3) finishing with a 418-250 yd edge in a 36-22 road victory (HOU without QB Stroud). The Browns are outgaining their road foes by a 343-332 clip on the year (-5 ppg) while the Texans have outscored their home opponents by 5 ppg with a 369-333 ypg edge.

This marks just the 3rd time since their '99 franchise return that CLE has earned a playoff berth. It is however the 2nd time in 3 ssn as they went into PIT in '20 to claim a 48-37 upset and nearly followed that up with another upset at the Chiefs a wk later (22-17 loss).

The Texans are back in the postssn for the 1st time s/'19. This marks the 7th time that HOU has reached the playoffs in their existence (s/'02) as they own a 4-6 all-time mark and have yet to get past the DIV Rnd (0-4 in those contests).

CLE HC Stefanski appears to be in line for COY honors after leading an injury-prone Browns squad to an 11-win regular ssn. The Browns did all of this despite starting 5 different QB's on the year! The veteran leadership of QB Flacco was the key piece to their late season surge as he's avg'd 323 ypg (60%, 13-8) over a 5-gm span. While the Texans have to feel very confident in their future with expected ROY QB Stroud and rookie HC Ryans, we're riding with the visitor here who rattled off 4 in a row SU and ATS before LW's virtual bye week where they used mostly reserves against the Bengals. CLE has 4 straight wins over HOU by 10 ppg and are confident following their win here in late December!

The Dolphins and Chiefs meet in the playoffs for the 4th time with MIA winning the 1st 3 including a 27-17 home win in the latest meeting way back in '94. These 2 actually met earlier TY with KC picking up a 21-14 win across the pond in London (292-267 yd edge). That victory by the Chiefs was the 4th straight dating back to '14 (12 pt avg MOV). MIA appeared to have the AFC East locked up a month ago before a 1 pt home loss to TEN, a substantial defeat in BAL and a blown 4Q lead LW at home against BUF. The Chiefs meanwhile won 3 of their L/4 to once again claim the AFC West Title. MIA was outscored by 3 ppg on the road TY (+47 ypg) while KC outscored their foes inside of Arrowhead by a 23-16 clip (+92 ypg).

The Dolphins have reached the postssn for a 2nd straight ssn although a late year collapse saw them lose out on the DIV Title and end up on the road for the WC Rnd. LY's WC trip to cold BUF saw them nearly pull off the outright upset as a 2 TD dog (34-31 loss).

The defending SB Champs return to postssn action for the 9th consec year although their 11-6 campaign wasn't the same dominating ssn as we're expecting to see with just a 4-4 record following their bye week.

The 7 pt loss LW at home against the Bills may have cost the warm-weathered Dolphins a chance at a significant run in TY's playoffs. Instead of a home matchup TW in South Beach, MIA now travels to KC in an evening matchup that has early forecasts as windy and temps near 0 degrees. Now we do remember that the Dolphins went in BUF LY in the playoffs and nearly came away with a win. This time could be a little different however as the team has been sputtering the last few weeks and continue to be bit significantly by the injury bug. With the Chiefs being a perennial playoff team and looking to repeat as champs, we have no issue giving them a TD lean here before another potential postssn showdown with the Bills.

This marks the 4th all-time playoff meeting between the Steelers and Bills with PIT owning a 2-1 mark including a 40-21 home victory in their last matchup all the way back in '95. PIT somehow found their way back in the postssn following a 3-gm winning streak to close out the year and a surprising collapse by the Jags that included a loss LW in Nashville. BUF meanwhile is one of the hottest teams going right now following LW's comeback win in MIA that was sparked by a 96-yd PR TD in the 4Q. BUF has now won 5 straight since their late ssn bye. These 2 met halfway through LY in BUF with the Bills (-14) picking up a dominating 38-3 win w/a 552-364 yd edge. PIT is being outscored by 3 ppg on the road TY (-13 ypg). BUF on the other hand has outscored their home foes by 9 ppg (+41 ypg).

The Steelers are in the postssn for the 3rd time in the past 4 years. Their previous 2 haven't worked out well however including WC Rnd losses at KC (21 pt loss in '21) and home against the Browns (11 pt loss in '20).

This marks the 5th consec playoff appearance for the Bills. The past 3 ssn's have seen them win at least 1 postssn matchup before being knocked out by the Bengals ('22) and Chiefs ('20 & '21).

HC Tomlin continues to impress with the Steelers as he's yet to have a losing campaign in his 17-year tenure. The Steelers now head into BUF as the biggest underdog of WC weekend after sneaking into this matchup. The Bills are at it again here as the look to FINALLY get back into the "Big Game" following a handful of missed opportunities the past few seasons against the Chiefs and Bengals. The Steelers have gotten some quality starts out of QB Rudolph the last 3 wks to get to this position although he's clearly a game-manager that needs a consistent running game. With BUF finishing #9 in the NFL in ypg allowed and the Steelers missing their top defensive guy in TJ Watt, we expect BUF to continue their recent hot streak in this one.

This marks the 9th all-time playoff meeting between the Packers and Cowboys with the 1st 8 being split at 4 apiece. The Packers have won the past 2 contests back in the '14 and '16 DIV Rnds. Along with the '16 postssn contest, GB has won 4 straight (all as dogs) including LY's 31-28 (+3) OT win in Lambeau. The Packers have outscored their road foes by 4 ppg on the year (-2 ypg) while DAL has been dominant at home outscoring their foes by 21 ppg (+120 ypg).

The Packers return to the playoffs for the 1st time s/'21 where they suffered a surprising 13-10 home loss (-5) to the 49ers as the #1 seed in the NFC. Prior to that defeat, GB had won at least 1 contest in each of the previous 5 playoff berths.

DAL is back in the postssn for the 3rd straight year although they haven't gotten past the DIV Rnd since way back in their SB-winning campaign of '95 (failed to advance 12 straight times incl LY when they lost 19-12 at SF in DIV Rnd).

Following a rough 2-5 start to the ssn in QB Love's 1st year as the #1 guy, the young signal-caller led the Packers to an outstanding finish to the ssn to land the final WC spot in the NFC. The Packers finished the regular ssn with 3 straight wins including a 23 pt road victory in MIN and a clinching 8 pt win at home against CHI. The Cowboys meanwhile took advantage of a stellar home record and a shocking slide by the Eagles to capture the NFC East for the 2nd time in 3 years (28 pt win LW in WAS). While the Packers have owned the series as of late and have gone on a solid 15-6 ATS run as an AD, the Cowboys are clearly a different team inside of their home venue with a perfect 8-0 SU mark (6-2 ATS).

The Rams and Lions meet in the postssn for the 1st time in the modern era. The Rams have come out on top in each of their past 2 regular ssn meetings with the Lions including a 28-19 home win in '21 where QB Stafford threw for 334 yards and 3 TD's against his former team (DET QB Goff 22-36-268-1-2 in 1st meeting vs LAR). Sitting at 3-6 heading into their bye week, the Rams finished with wins in 7 of their final 8 to land a WC spot (6-1 ATS run coming in). DET meanwhile took LY's strong finish into a hot start TY with a win on the road against defending SB Champ KC on opening nights (5-1 start to the ssn). Had it not been for a narrow road loss in DAL in Wk 17, the Lions would be sitting as the #2 seed in the NFC. The Rams have struggled away from home TY being outscored by 6 ppg (-105 ypg) while DET has outscored their home foes by 9 ppg (+117 ypg).

The '21 SB Champion Rams return to the playoffs following a rough '22 campaign that saw them finish just 5-12 due to inconsistent play and a plethora of key injuries on both sides of the ball.

The Lions earned a postssn berth for the 1st time s/'16 with their 1st ever NFC North Title (last DIV Champ came back in '91 when they were in the NFC Central). That '91 ssn was also the last time they won a playoff game (dropped 8 straight WC gms since).

Three years ago the Rams gave a king's ransom to acquire Matthew Stafford on the Lions. While the Stafford era began with a SB Title, the vast amount of draft picks along with the addition former Ram Jared Goff has also begun to pay dividends for DET. Stafford now makes his 1st trip back to where he spent the 1st 10 years to take on a Lions squad that's 18-7 ATS inside of Ford Field dating back to the end on 2020. With the Rams also on their previously mentioned 6-1 ATS run coming in, the better option here could be the "Over" as DET has hit the total on 11 of 17 contests TY while the Rams have scored 30 ppg the past 7 wks.
