KEY SELECTIONS

4★ VIRGINIA TECH over Old Dominion - The home team has won all four prior meetings (3-1 ATS) with ODU pulling upsets both in '18 and last year. VTech was playing in their first game under HC Pry last year. They held a 333-249 yd edge but Grant Wells threw 4 int's and one of ODU's td's came after VT botched a fg snap. The Hokies have 14 starters back. Wells looked much improved in the spring and we love the addition of NC A&T RB Bhayshul Tuten (1363, 6.6 LY) and ODU's best player from last year, WR Ali Jennings, now plays for the Hokies. ODU only has 7 starters back after finishing just 3-9 last year. New QB Grant Wilson was a backup at Fordham last year and followed OC Kevin Deck here. VTech has edges in all 3 phases and is much more experienced (#65 vs #130). The Hokies are out for legit revenge and they are laying just over 2 td's which is a cheap price in Blacksburg with 'Enter Sandman' on opening weekend!

FORECAST: VIRGINIA TECH BY 24

3★ COLORADO ST (+) over Washington St - These teams met a season ago at WSU and the Cougars (-16) went ahead 28-0 at HT (257-82) and went on to win 38-7 (+193 yds) over the Rams. CSU enters year 2 under HC Norvell in much better shape than LY and are returning 15 st's led by QB Millen (hit 72% LY!) and AA candidate WR Horton (1131, 15.9 LY) on offense and S Howell on defense. WSU does return 12 st's incl 7 on offense led by QB Ward and RB Watson, but they do lose their top 4 WR's from last season. Norvell is 9-3 ATS all-time as a home dog and WSU does host Wisconsin next week, so there could be some look-ahead there and the line is just under 2 td's and we think CSU can keep this game real close at home. **FORECAST: Washington St by 3**

3★ IOWA over Utah St - 3rd meeting, but first since 2002. The Hawkeyes are 11-1-1 vs current MWC foes, but just 5-4 ATS s/'88. Utah St is 1-15 SU all-time vs Big10 schools and lost 55-0 to P5 opponent Alabama LY. The Aggies are off a 6-7 season and have just 4 starters back from an offense that avg'd 22 ppg game last season and 5 starters from a defense that allowed 194 rush ypg. The Hawkeyes dipped into the transfer portal to address their underperforming offense, as they added former Michigan starting QB Cade McNamara, TE Erick All (Mich) and VHT WR Kaleb Brown (PS#7) from Ohio St. The Iowa defense was #2 in the NCAA allowing just 13 ppg LY and their are loaded once again. Ferentz is 12-4 ATS vs non-conf foes s/'18 and we don't see the Aggies generating much offense and despite the noise, this Iowa offense is much improved with McNamara under center and we think they'll get it rolling in preparation for their meeting with in-state rival Iowa St next week. **FORECAST: IOWA by 31**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ MIAMI, FL over Miami, Oh (FRI) - The Canes have won all 3 previous meetings but the Miami's haven't met since 1987. UM is 16-0 SU in home openers going 11-5 ATS but 11 of those were against FCS foes. MU is 0-15 in their road opener and have failed to cover their last 6 first road trips. The Redhawks lost at Kentucky 37-13 (+15) in the opener last year but did upset Northwestern on the road 17-14 (+7). This game is a part of a 3 game road trip to start the '23 season for MU with UMass and Cincinnati on deck. HC Cristobal is excited about this year's 'Canes team with 19 starters back and they should be vastly improved off a 5-7 season. MU has 16 starters back and will benefit from having a healthy QB Gabbert back after he battled injuries last year. Cristobal will want to get his team some confidence going into Texas A&M next week and MU is just 7-16 ATS vs non-conference and will have trouble dealing with the Florida heat. **FORECAST: MIAMI, FL by 24**

2★ WYOMING (+) over Texas Tech - Teams have met 5 previous times, but the last meeting came back in 1992! The last time WY hosted a P5 team was '19 vs Mizzou (+16) and they pulled the upset 37-31. WY enters '23 in much better shape than LY as they return 15 st's incl 10 on defense from a unit that allowed 370 ypg and collected 37 sks. WY did lose RB McNeely for the season (inj) in August, but still have a strong RB room and are #21 in experience enter the season. TT also comes into '23 with experience (#25) as they return 17 st's incl all 11 on offense led by QB Shough, RB Brooks, and their top 5 WR's, but do travel to the elevation in Wyoming where the Cowboys are 6-2 ATS as a home dog since 2019. Texas Tech is an away favorite for just the second time since 2020 and they have a much tougher home game on deck vs Oregon. We expect WY to hang around and call for TT to win only by a TD. **FORECAST: TEXAS TECH by 6**

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY AUGUST 31ST

UCF by 37 over Kent St - Once upon a time these teams were conference foes in the MAC and last met back in 2004 with Kent St winning 41-24 on the road. Fast forward to 2023 and UCF enters their 1st season in the Big 12 and the 4 teams that moved into the conf this fall, they look to be in the best shape to compete right away. UCF brings back 15 st's led by dynamic QB Plumlee (2586 pass yds, 862 rush yds, 25 td's LY) and 7 st's are back on defense. Kent St enters full rebuild mode for 2023 as they return just FOUR total starters and have a new HC in former RB cch Kenni Burns. UCF has a huge edge in experience (#9 vs #132) and they have a massive edge on offense (#17 vs #111) and defense (#69 vs #122) plus enter this game 12-2 SU at home under HC Malzahn winning by an avg of 22 points. While Kent St is just 3-8 ATS as an away dog since 2020, we have UCF winning by over 5 td's but that is right near the line and UCF has a big game at Boise St on deck and could pull starters 2H if they are up big.

NC State by 10 over CONNECTICUT - UConn was no match for NCSU last year, trailing 31-0 2Q but they did manage to cover as 38' pt dogs, scoring with 2:08 left for a 41-10 loss. The Huskies went on to win 5 of their last 7 games, reaching a bowl in HC Mora's first year. UConn has 17 starters back and made a big improvement at QB, adding Maine transfer Joe Fagnano who had a 46-12 ratio in 4 years. NCSU has 12 starters back. HC Doeren brought in OC Robert Anae and added QB Brennan Armstrong who threw for 4,449 in '21 with Anae as OC at Virginia but struggled last year under a new OC. UConn has a huge experience edge (#12 vs #86) and they upset another ACC foe, Boston College, at home 13-3 last year. NCSU has a huge home game against Notre Dame on deck. The Huskies only had 39 pass yards against the 'Pack last year but we think Fagnano's addition makes a big difference and Mora went 9-4 ATS last year including 5-1 ATS at home.

MINNESOTA by 3 over Nebraska - These teams have met every year since 2011 and the Gophers are 7-5 SU and 6-6 ATS in those matchups, but they have won 4 straight meetings and have covered in 4 of the last 5. Last year in Lincoln, the Gophers held the Huskers to just 267 yards in a 20-13 road win. This year marks a transition for Minn as for the first time in 3 years QB Tanner Morgan and RB Mohamed Ibrahim will not be in the backfield. The "Greek Gunslinger" Athan Kaliakmanis takes over as the starter at QB. He did start 5 gms LY and threw for 946 (54.1%) with a 3-4 ratio as the Gophers went 3-2 SU/ATS in his starts. Minn added Western Mich transfer RB Sean Tyler, who rushed for 1,027 (4.9) for the Broncos last year. Defensively, the Gophers return 6 starters from a unit that allowed just 14 ppg and 295 ypg, led by S Tyler Nubin (4 ints LY) who will be an early round draft pick. Nebraska begins the Matt Rhule and he inherits 15 starters and quickly identified Georgia Tech transfer Jeff Sims as his QB. Sims made 23 starts at GT the LY and threw for 4,464 (58%) and a 30-23 ratio. The Husker defense was gashed early last season as they allowed over 520 yards in 4 of their first 7 games, but did show improvement the last 5 as they allowed 334 ypg, so that was something to build on. Both of these teams will look to establish the run, so we think this could be a tight, lower scoring game and we'll give the home team a close win, but do like the Huskers with the points in Rhule's debut.

UTAH by 3 over Florida - Utah is out for revenge after allowing a td with 1:25 left to lose 29-26 (-2) in last year's opener. Florida brings back talented RB duo Montrell Johnson & Trevor Etienne and they did gash Utah's run D for 283 yards (7.3) last year. HC Napier added Wisconsin transfer Graham Mertz and has 11 returning starters. Utah won 10 games last year and has a big experience edge (#28 vs #109) but they have two big injury concerns with both QB Cam Rising (65%, 3034, 26-8, 465 rush) and TE Brant Kuithe both ?. HC Napier is 16-4-2 as an underdog with 9 outright upsets going back to his days at Louisiana. They did stay within a td on the road last year vs both Tennessee and Florida St and upset Texas A&M. It's tough to go against Utah at home with the elevation advantage but Napier has consistently kept these kind of games close so we side with the dog.

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 1ST

MICHIGAN ST by 12 over Central Michigan - 1st meeting since 2018. The Spartans have won 7 of the 8 recent matchups but the Chippewas have covered in 5 of those, including the last 2. CMU has 13 starters back from a squad that went 4-8 last season, despite being just -8 ypg on the year. They have to replace a 3-year starter at QB and will likely play 2 here. Jase Bauer and Bert Emanuel both started 1 game each LY and Bauer is the better passer, while Emanuel excels with his feet, as he was the team's 2nd leading rusher (496, 7.4). The Chippewas return 9 starters from a D that allowed 28 ppg and 375 ypg. Michigan St has 13 starters back, but the offense was hit hard by transfers as both starting QB Thorne and leading WR Coleman both hit the portal. Noah Kim looked good in limited action last year (74%, 3-0), but is certainly unproven as the starter. The Spartans added 4 FBS transfers along the DLine, so they should be more physical than last year's group that allowed 179 (4.3) rush yards a game. CMU has covered 3 of their last 4 vs P5 teams (incl 2-0 LY) and we think they can be competitive, but we see this one close to the line.

† Louisville by 3 over Georgia Tech - Atlanta. This game is being played in Mercedes Benz Stadium. This is only the 3rd meeting between these ACC foes, with GT winning both by 35 in '18 and 19 in '20. The Jackets have 12 starters back from a team that went 5-7 last year but did play better down the stretch under Brent Key who was named Full Time HC after the season. GT upset NCar and only trailed 10-7 at half vs Georgia in their last two games. UL has 13 starters back for first year HC Jeff Brohm. They brought in QB Jack Plummer who started 13 games for Brohm at Purdue from '19-'21 then threw for 3,095 (63%, 21-9) at Cal last year. GT brought in Texas A&M transfer Haynes King. UL is going from a dual threat, mobile QB and while they are clearly the more talented roster, it may take a few games to adapt to Brohm's offense while GT played 8 games under Pry last year.

HAWAII by 1 over Stanford - Last met back in 1972. UH has won and covered their last two home games against Pac-12 teams as they beat both Oregon St and Arizona back in 2019. UH comes into this game with a game under their belt, having played at Vanderbilt last Saturday and lost just 35-28 where QB Schager threw for 351 yds & 3 td's. Meanwhile this is the opener for Stanford, who return just six total starters and have a new HC Troy Taylor and come into this season just #131 in experience, while UH has an experienced team (#44) as they have 14 total starters back including 9 on defense. UH got a lot better as the season went on last year under HC Chang and now they had a full offseason to learn the offense. Stanford does have their Pac-12 opener on deck against a much better USC team and UH finished the season covering their final 4 games as a home underdog in '22 and have now covered 8 of their L/9 games overall, and we will call for UH to pull the outright upset!

SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 2ND

BAYLOR by 28 over Texas St - Third straight season these teams meet. In '21 Baylor (-14) won just 29-20 and last season the Bears (-30) were up 21-7 HT and 28-7 into 4Q before getting 2 quick scores 4Q and won 42-7. TXST enters just #125 in experience as they brought in former Incarnate Word HC Kinne, who added several transfers from UIW along with P5 transfers including QB's Malik Hornsby (Arkansas) and TJ Finley (Auburn). Baylor does return 12 st's including 7 on offense led by QB Shapen and three of their top four WR's are back along with freshman AA RB Reese! Baylor has a huge edge on both offense (#27 vs #94) and defense (#49 vs #132). The Bears do have a much bigger home game next week when they host Utah, so they could be overlooking this game a bit, but we think Baylor wins by 4 td's against a TXST team that added over 50 new players this offseason and they could take some time to gel.

MICHIGAN by 40 over East Carolina - 1st meeting. Michigan is 10-4 ATS in home openers s/'09, but is just 2-2 ATS in their L/4 vs AAC foes. ECU has not won a season opener s/'16 and is 0-6 SU and 2-4 ATS in those games and is 3-8 ATS vs ranked tm s/'15. The Pirates are in a rebuilding year as they have just 10 starters back and will have a new starting QB for the 1st time since in 5 years. Mason Garcia (PS#41) is big-bodied QB (6-5 250) and has all the physical tools, but has only made 1 career start. Michigan is loaded on both sides of the ball and this is probably Harbaugh's best team here. He will miss this one (sus), but that shouldn't impact the outcome. ECU took NC State to the wire in last season's opener, but the Wolverines are a different beast. Mike Houston is 11-4 as an AD, but Michigan beat their 3 non-con opps 166-17 last year and we see no reason for them to call off the dogs in this one.

LIBERTY by 6 over Bowling Green - The Falcons won the only prior meeting 62-3 but that was in 2003 when the Flames were still in the FCS. Liberty has won 3 straight home openers covering the last 2 including upsetting UAB 29-27 last year as a 6' pt HD. Bowling Green has lost 7 straight road openers (most vs P5 teams) with their only cover in '21 at Tennessee (lost 38-6 as 35 pt AD). Still this year is Liberty lost their 4 year HC and return just 8 starters as they are #119 in experience. Bowling Green on the other hand is under their 5th yr HC and return 13 starters (#71 experience). They are led by QB Conner Bazalak, who made a combined 20 starts the last 2 years at Missouri & Indiana. While Liberty still has the edge on both offense (#86-#94) and defense (#104-#129) they are switching their offense and defense and may take a few games to get on the same page. With the Flames opening as an 10 pt HF we will take the Falcons & the points.

OKLAHOMA by 31 over Arkansas St - Last met back in 2000 here where OU won 45-7 over Ark St. OU is off a disappointing 6-7 season in HC Venables 1st season LY and bring back 13 st's incl QB Gabriel and arguably the best DLine in the Big 12. Ark St is in year 3 under HC Jones, and he brought in transfers at key positions incl at QB with Colorado transfer JT Shrout, to try and get this program back to a bowl. Ark St thrived in the role of being a road underdog in 2022 as they went 5-1 ATS in that role including trailing just 24-9 HT at Ohio St and were just -5 FD's for the game. Ark St also led at HT in three road losses a season ago. The Sooners have a much bigger game on deck against SMU next week, and last year in home non-conf games won by 32 vs UTEP and 30 vs Kent St and as of now the line is hovering around 5 td's, so we will lean slightly with the Red Wolves to keep this game within the line.

OHO St by 34 over INDIANA - The Buckeyes have won 28 straight in the series (14-13-1 ATS) and the visitor is on 5-2 ATS run. OSU won 56-14 (+40) in Columbus LY as they outscored the Hoosiers 662-269 and the Buckeyes scored a td with 9 mins left to give them the cover. OSU brings 14 starters back and come it at #59 on our experience chart, while IU has just 8 starters back and is #123 in experience. The Hoosiers will rely on transfers at nearly every position, including QB where Tennessee transfer Taven Jackson (PS#21) appears to have won the starting job. Jackson 3 passes in mop-up duty last yr. Defensively, IU added 16 transfers in hopes of improving a D that allowed 449 ypg and 34 ppg, which were both near the bottom of the Big10. The Buckeyes have to replace QB CJ Stroud (#2 overall DC HOU) and Kyle McCord and Devin Brown are both going to play in this one. They do return the best WR corps in the country, led by Marvin Harrison (1263, 16.4) and Emeka Egbuka (1151, 15.6). OSU has AA candidates at all 3 levels on defense and should improve even more in year #2 of DC Jim Knowles 3-safety defense. It's a tough ask for a rFR QB to make his first career start vs 1 of the best defenses in the B10 and we like the Buckeyes to continue their win & cover ways in Bloomington.

PURDUE by 7 over Fresno St - First meeting. Fresno last faced a Big 10 team in '19 when they hosted Minnesota and lost just 38-35 in 2OT. Purdue loses their QB, top 2 WR's and overall just return 11 starters and are under a 1st year HC in Ryan Walters who spent the previous 2 seasons in the Big 10 as the DC at Illinois. Purdue does add former Texas QB Card who has exp. Fresno has an exp'd HC in Jeff Tedford, but they lose QB Haener, their 1400-yd RB and top 3 WR's on offense, though they do return 7 st'rs on defense where on paper they have the defensive edge over Purdue (#50 vs #97) and they have a HUGE edge on ST's (#37 vs #123). While Fresno brings in QB Keene from UCF (11 sts) and Tedford is 8-3 ATS as an away dog here, we think Purdue has the overall talent edge and wins by a td & the current line is Purdue by just over a fg.

TEMPLE by 15 over Akron - Both teams are under 2nd year HC's and are former MAC East divisional foes ('07-'11). Temple is 7-5 SU & ATS vs Akron including winning and covering the last 6. Last met in '21, when Temple (-6) trailed 14-0 but led 24-17 at HT and won 45-24. LTH Akron was a 29' pt AD. The Zips only trailed 6-0 at HT but gave up a front door cover td with 2:46 left in a 30-0 loss. Akron returns 14 starters and are our #41 experienced team but Temple returns 16 starters and are our #24 experienced team. Akron has lost 4 straight road openers with their only cover being in the 2020 Covid season when they only lost 24-10 as a 27' pt AD at Ohio. The Owls are 3-1 SU but just 2-2 ATS with both covers vs FCS foes. Temple has only a #73-#75 offensive edge they have a big defensive edge (#96-#123). The Owls were 2-0 SU & ATS as a DD favorite last year in their first year under HC Drayton and we look for that trend to continue here.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 4 over Northern Illinois - BC is 3-0 SU in this series but their last two wins in '15 & '17 were by 3 points each. NIU returns 15 starters after going 3-9 last year but was only -23 ypg and lost to #8 Kentucky by just 8 points (31-23) as 26' pt dogs. BC also went 3-9 last year. They have 15 starters back and the Eagles have the most improved Oline in the country, going from 4 career starts last year to 137 this year. NIU still has a slight experience edge (#19 vs #34) and will benefit from having a healthy QB Lombardi. The Huskies are 5-2 ATS vs Power 5 schools. BC is on a 4-10 ATS run and went 0-4 ATS vs non-conference last year while HC Hammond is 12-4 as an away dog. With the angles clearly favoring NIU and the Huskies getting just under double-digits we prefer to take the points.

KENTUCKY by 31 over Ball St - KY has won 16 straight non-conference regular season games (11-5 ATS) since 2018. The only prior meeting was in '01 when the 'Cats won 28-20. KY also beat a MAC foe in Miami, OH in last year's opener 37-13 (-15) but later failed to cover vs Northern Illinois 31-23 (-26). Ball St is 0-11 SU/4-7 ATS vs SEC foes and also has Georgia on deck. The Cardinals have 14 starters back and added Texas St transfer QB Layne Hatcher and Kent St RB Marquez Cooper (1331, 4.7, 1st Tm All-MAC). KY has 15 starters back and brought in NCSU transfer Devin Leary to play under OC Liam Coen who returns after spending last year in the NFL. KY only has FCS Eastern Kentucky on deck and is 13-8 as a HF since '18. The 'Cats have a huge edge on defense and Coen opened up the offense in '21's opener when KY beat ULM 45-10 (-31). We expect something similar here.

North Carolina by 1 over South Carolina - Charlotte. This game is being played in Bank of America Stadium in Charlotte, NC. The last meeting was also played in Charlotte when SC won the Duke's Mayo Bowl in '21, 38-21 (+11). The Heels have 17 starters back including QB Drake Maye but took a big hit with the loss of Kent St transfer WR Tez Walker who was ruled ineligible and is appealing. SC had an impressive finish last year, upsetting Tennessee and Clemson in back-to-back weeks but lost their bowl vs Notre Dame 45-38 (+3). The Gamecocks finished 8-5 with 4 of their wins coming in outright upsets. NC's defense should be much improved after purging some of the issues and they brought in a new DC. Spencer Rattler had a slow start to last year's season with a 2-5 ratio in his first four games and has a less experienced RB group with little depth behind him. NC has one of the deepest RB units in the ACC and a renewed emphasis on running the ball which we think makes the difference in a close game.

WISCONSIN by 31 over Buffalo - The Badgers won the only prior meeting 35-3 in 2006 but they failed to cover as a 38 pt HF. The Bulls are 3-16 vs current Big Ten teams but while they are just 1-6 SU in those games since 2013 they are 5-2 ATS. Buffalo is 2-4 SU but 4-2 ATS in road openers. The Badgers are 26-1 in home openers (lost to Penn St in '21) including 6-2 ATS since 2015. Wisconsin returns 18 starters while Buffalo returns just 10 as the Badgers have a good size experience edge (#20-#61). The Badgers have a huge edge on both offense (#19-#74) and defense (#12-#119). Wisconsin is under new HC Luke Fickell, who is making some changes on both sides of the ball. With a trip to Washington St on deck, they will likely want to get the offense as much experience as they can, so even if up big don't expect them to call of the dogs (or the badgers).

ILLINOIS by 6 over Toledo - 1st Meeting. Illinois is 7-1 SU & 6-2 ATS in home openers, but is just 3-2 (1-4 ATS) vs MAC foes s/'16, including a home loss to EMU back in '19. The Illini are coming off a somewhat surprising 8-5 season (8-5 ATS) and they have 12 starters back and are just #116 on our experience chart. Offensively, Illinois has to replace 1,600 yd rusher Chase Brown and QB Tommy DeVito. Ole Miss transfer Luke Altmyer (PS#24) was named the starter at QB. He's talented, but he's only made 1 career start. The Illini D finished #1 in the FBS allowing just 12.7 ppg and 274 ypg (FBS #3), but has to replace 3 NFL draft picks in the secondary, including AA CB Devon Witherspoon who was the #5 overall pick in the draft. Toledo went 9-5 LY (5-9 ATS) and bring back 16 starters and are #11 in our experience chart. QB Dequan Finn (2nd Tm MAC) returns after throwing for 2,260 (59.7%) with a 23-12 ratio and was the team's 2nd leading rusher with 631 (4.9), despite only starting 7 games. The Rockets also return their leading rusher, receiver and 4 starters on the OLine. Defensively, the Rockets have 8 starters back including CB Quinyon Mitchell who led the FBS with 25 passes defended (5 int, 20 pbu). The Rockets took Notre Dame to the wire in '21 (32-29 loss), so they aren't intimidated by P5 opponents and we think the Rockets can hang with the Illini and keep this one within the line.

TCU by 27 over Colorado - Only prior meeting came last season in the opener where TCU (-14) led just 7-6 HT and were -145 yds but outscored CU in the 2H 31-7 (346-136). This is the first game for the Buffs under HC Sanders who brought in over 70 new players this offseason via the portal incl QB Shedeur Sanders and Travis Hunter (Jackson St) along with RB McCaskill (Houston) but the big question is how all of those players will gel together? Meanwhile TCU is off a ssn where they made the national title game, however they do return just 10 st'rs and lose QB Duggan, RB Miller and WR Johnston all to the NFL. However QB Morris originally beat out Duggan for the job LY and they add

Bama transfers in RB Trey Sanders and WE Jojo Earle. TCU does have 7 st'rs back on defense and they have a big edge over CU (#47 vs #117). HC Dykes was 4-1 ATS LY as a home favorite and they only have an FCS team on deck. We feel that teams will pour it on against CU if they have the chance and we expect TCU in front of their home crowd to win by nearly 4 td's.

BYU by 24 over Sam Houston - First meeting and SH's first FBS game is a trip into the elevation of Provo. The Bearcats went 5-4 last year as HC KC Keeler redshirted key players in a meaningless season. They did cover as 33' pt dogs at A&M, losing 31-0. BYU has 15 starters back and added Pitt/USC transfer QB Kedon Slovis who only had a 10-9 ratio last year. The Cougars only have Southern Utah on deck but they were 1-4 as a HF last year and they've failed to cover 5 of their last 6 as chalk of -21 or more. SH made the FCS playoffs 9 times since 2011 so the step up in competition won't be overwhelming but we do worry that they will wear down against BYU's size and depth and the elevation could be a big factor in the 2nd half.

USC by 38 over Nevada - These teams have met 5 times but the last meeting was back in 1929. USC has a game under their belt after winning 56-28 against San Jose St last week where QB Williams threw for 278 yds & 4 td's, while this is the opener for Nevada. The 'Pack are in much better shape in year 2 under HC Wilson as they return 14 st'rs. USC does still have the big edge in experience (#10 vs #92) and they have a massive edge on both offense (#2 vs #89) and defense (#54 vs #110). While the Trojans are 5-3 ATS as a home favorite under HC Riley, USC has their Pac-12 opener on deck against Stanford, so we'll call for a Trojans blowout win, but the line is sitting at over 5 td's which is right where we see this game finishing up.

WASHINGTON by 10 over Boise St - The last time these teams met was in the 2019 in the Las Vegas Bowl where UW won easily 38-7 (+75 yds, +3 TO's) in former HC Peterson's final game. The Huskies return 15 st'rs under HC DeBoer led by QB Penix and gets back his top 4 receivers. Boise also returns their stars on offense as dynamic QB Green is back along with the 1-2 punch of RB's Holani and Jeanty but did lose their top WR Caples for the season (inj). While the Huskies are 5-2 ATS as a home favorite under HC DeBoer, this is a Boise team we feel can compete with UW and the Broncos are 4-1 ATS as an away dog under HC Avalos and both teams are pretty exp'd (UW #22, Boise #52). The line currently sits slightly above 2 td's and we think the Huskies win by just under 2 td's, so our lean is slightly on the Broncos.

UCLA by 20 over Coastal Carolina - First meeting. This is CC's furthest regular season trip out west since moving up to the FBS. CC returns 14 st'rs including superstar QB McCall and overall the offense returns 8 st'rs, but they do have a new HC in Tim Beck. UCLA brings back 16 st'rs under HC Kelly, but they do lose their QB Thompson-Robinson & RB Charbonnet, but bring in Ball St transfer RB Steele (1556, 5.6 LY). These teams rank fairly even in offense (#18 UCLA, #36 CC), ST's (#47 UCLA, #56 CC) and experience (CC #33, UCLA #45) and UCLA typically doesn't get great crowds for non-conference games. While CC on a 5-1 ATS run against Power 5 teams and a 6-3 ATS run as an away dog, this is their first game under a new coach while UCLA has an exp'd HC and they have a big edge on defense (#41 vs #111). CC may be able to hang with UCLA for a bit, but ultimately we see the Bruins pulling away and winning by over 2 td's.

ALABAMA by 41 over Middle Tennessee - MT is 3-0 ATS vs Bama but last met in 2015 when the Blue Raiders were +35 and only lost 37-10. Bama has 10 starters back and haven't named a starting QB, with 3 possible candidates, dual threat Jalen Milroe, Notre Dame transfer Tyler Buchner and rFr Ty Simpson. MT has 13 starters back after going 8-5 last year. MT has lost their last five road openers (1-4 ATS) including last year when they laid an egg at James Madison, getting dominated 44-7 (+5). The Blue Raiders did break a 7 game losing streak vs P5's when they beat Miami but they aren't upsetting the Tide and the last time they traveled to an SEC school was a 49-7 loss at Georgia in '18. Bama does have Texas on deck but Saban is 6-1 ATS as 40+ favorites and won 55-0 vs Utah St the week before Texas last year. With so many QB's in the mix they will let the offense run late and could take on an extra td or two.

AUBURN by 34 over UMass - There's a renewed energy in Auburn with the Hugh Freeze era starting. This is the first meeting. Auburn went just 5-7 last year, holding onto a lame-duck head coach far too long. Don Brown's UMass squad did travel to A&M last year and only lost 20-3 (+32') and the Minutemen have impressively covered their last 9 vs SEC foes. UMass has already matched last year's win total after beating NMSU 41-30 (+7) on the road last week. Clemson/UConn transfer Taisun Phommachanh threw for 192 yards and rushed for 96. The Minutemen were outgained 470-389 but were +3 TO's. Auburn has 17 starters back, led by Michigan St transfer QB Peyton Thorne and RB Jarquez Hunter (675, 6.5) may be the best RB that Freeze has coached. UMass has 15 starters back and while they only went 1-11 last year Auburn does have a trip to Cal on deck. Freeze's Liberty squad played UMass just last year when they were laying 24 pts but only won 42-24, giving up a late td. The Tigers will build confidence but we see no reason they would run the score up.

TEXAS A&M by 41 over New Mexico - A&M has won all 5 prior meetings and are 4-0 ATS since 2008. They last met in '21 when the Aggies held a 429-122 yd edge and won 34-0 (-31). The Aggies have a HUGE experience edge with 20 starters back (#14 vs #126). Bobby Petrino was brought in to improve the offense and we like Soph QB Connor Weigman who started 4 games and had an 8-0 ratio last year. NM has 10 starters back. The Lobos have 8 starters back on offense and added UAB transfer Dylon Hopkins but they only averaged 13 ppg and 229 ypg last year and were shutout at LSU 38-0 (+31). Now they face an A&M defense that has 10 starters back and held foes 37 ypg below their average last year. The Lobos have failed to score a single point in their two games vs SEC teams under Danny Gonzales and we could see a similar outcome here. A&M has Miami on deck but Jimbo has to build some excitement and confidence so we see a lopsided score here.

WESTERN KENTUCKY by 14 over Usf - USF leads the series 4-3, but the teams haven't met since 2015. USF fired HC Jeff Scott after he went just 4-29 in his 3 ssn's and the Bulls brought in Tennessee OC Alex Golesh to lead the program. This is Golesh's first HC job. USF did not beat an FBS team LY and finished #130 in the FBS allowing 41 ppg. They do have 9 starters back from that defense, added 11 transfers and brought in DC Todd Orlando who Golesh considers the top DC in the country. WKU is off back-to-back 9 wins seasons and returns their starting QB, leading rusher and #1 WR from an offense that avg'd 36 ppg. QB Austin Reed threw for 4,744 (64.5%) with a 40-11 ratio and WR Malachi Corley was #4 in the country with 1293 rec yds (12.8). The Hilltoppers only return 4 starters on defense, but leading tackler JaQuies Evans (106 tkl, 95kls!) is back. WKU did face DC Orlando's defense in last year's season finale when Orlando was at FAU and we think that gives the Hilltoppers another advantage over a Bulls team with a lot of unknowns.

Over 41 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 59% winners over 41 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years INCLUDING 3 MORE OUTRIGHT UPSET WINNERS IN 2022!!! Here is This week's Underdog Play:

South Alabama +6' over TULANE

South Alabama over TULANE - Only 3rd meeting. Last one came in 2020 where SAAla (+10') led Tulane 14-6 HT and allowed Tulane to score to GW TD late 4Q in a 27-24 loss. Tulane enters '23 after a remarkable 12-2 season LY where they upset USC in the Cotton Bowl. Tulane returns 14 st'rs led by QB Pratt, but they do lose their top RB, top 2 WR's and their top 5 tacklers. SAAla is off a 10-3 season where both regular ssn's losses were by a comb'd 5 points. SAAla returns 9 st'rs each on both sides of the ball led by QB Bradley, RB Webb, their top 2 WR's and their top 6 tkl'rs. SAAla does have the big edge on defense (#29 vs #70) plus they are #4 in experience while Tulane is #56. The Green Wave are 16-4 ATS as a home favorite since 2019, but SAAla was 4-0 ATS in non-conf regular season games LY and are getting nearly a full td here while Tulane has a big home game against Ole Miss next week and might experience a hangover after last year's 12 win season.

FORECAST: South Alabama by 3

TEXAS by 31 over Rice - This is the 97th meeting. Texas has won 15 straight meetings and 43 of their last 44 meetings with the lone loss in than span coming in 1994. Last met in '21 here and Texas led 44-0 by HT (391-125) and won 58-0 (+348 yds). Expectations are high for Texas this season as they return 16 st'rs including 10 on offense led by QB Ewers, WR Worthy and one of the top OLines in all of CFB. Rice is coming off a season where they made a bowl for the 1st time in 8 ssn's and return 15 st'rs under 6th year HC Bloomgren, plus they add veteran QB JT Daniels, who has previously played at USC, UGA and WVU. The line currently sits around 5 td's and with Texas having a MASSIVE game at Alabama on deck, a lot of their attention is likely on that matchup and we feel this Rice team has enough talent to keep this game within the line.

Utah by 5 over HOUSTON - 4th meeting. The home team is 0-3 SU & 1-2 ATS, including a 37-35 (-4) 3 OT road win for Houston last season. The Cougars trailed 21-7 late in the 3Q, but scored 17 unanswered in the 4th to take a 24-21 lead with 23 secs left then allowed UTSA to come right back down the field and tie it with a fg as time expired. The Cougars stopped the Roadrunners on their 2-pt attempt in the 3rd OT to secure the win, despite being outgained 441-346. Houston returns just 12 starters and check in at #103 on our experience chart. They must replace their 3-year starter at QB, top 2 WR's and top 5 tacklers on defense. They did take Texas Tech transfer QB Donovan Smith, who started 8 gms for the Red Raiders the L2Y. UTSA is off back-to-back DD win seasons and have 16 starters back (#13 exp), including QB Frank Harris who's in his 5th season as the starting QB and is a true dual-threat. The road team has owned this series and UTSA has covered 2 of 3 vs the Cougars, so we'll side with an experienced Roadrunners squad behind dynamic QB Harris.

California by 3 over NORTH TEXAS - These teams have only met once before (2019) and it's Cal's first regular season trip to Texas since 2015. Despite making back-to-back bowls, NT fired HC Seth Littrell and brought in Eric Morris to implement his version of the "Air Raid" offense. The Mean Green have 15 returning starters. Morris brought in ULM transfer Chandler Rogers to run the show and his 18 career starts under his belt. UNT returns 3 players that rushed for over 500 yds, so we expect them to be a bit more run-heavy early in the year as Morris installs his sytem. Cal has 17 starters back and this is Cal's most talented team (on paper) in quite a while. They are breaking in a new QB and that transition will likely define the Bears' season. TCU transfer Samuel L Jackson (PS#34) won the starting QB job, but he's only thrown 6 passes in 2 seasons. Many consider this a make-or-break year for Cal HC Justin Wilcox so they have this as a must-win and while we think their overall talent will eventually prevail, we'll take the home team against a Cal squad that is just 3-8-1 as an AF the last 6 seasons.

Tennessee by 32 over Virginia - Nashville. This game is being played in Nissan Stadium in Nashville, TN. This is the Vols 3rd time opening in Nashville, beating WY 47-7 (-30') in '02 and BG 59-30 (-21') in '15. They last met in the '91 Sugar Bowl. The Vols must get an early start on replacing Hendon Hooker last year when Joe Milton led wins over Vandy & Clemson. UVA had 13 starters back for 2nd year HC Tony Elliott. They added Monmouth transfer QB Tony Muskett and Clemson RB Kobe Pace to go with a solid D that allowed 358 ypg last year. The Cavaliers biggest must replace two All-ACC CB's and this isn't the ideal team to open with as Heupel's offense will throw downfield often and Milton's may have the strongest arm in the country. UT is 5-2 ATS when laying 28 points or more. Last year they often scored late td's even with the games well in hand. We look for the Vols to do the same with true frosh QB Nico lamaleava possibly seeing action late.

Army by 7 over ULM - The Black Knights lead the series 2-0 SU/ATS by a combined 85-31 but this is the first trip here. Last year despite being a 6' pt AD, the Warhawks led 17-7 late 2Q but allowed a 64 yd td run with 1:22 left to lose 48-24. Due to NCAA rule changes that limited Army's blocking style the Knights are changing their offense and while they will still have a run heavy attack on offense they will be spreading the offense more and adding more passing. ULM has the edges on both offense (#65-#106) and defense (#95-#133) but this early season game will also be decided by experience and Army has a huge edge (#42-#122). ULM returns just 10 starters and lose their top 2 QB's, their top 4 rushers and 4 of their top 6 receivers. Army returns 17 starters including their top 2 receivers and 2 of their top 3 rushers and while they lose their top 3 QB's none of them had experience in the new read option QB, so their loss is not a critical. ULM is 5-2 as a HD the last 2 years. While this is a talent vs experience game we will lean slightly with experience here.

SMU by 21 over Louisiana Tech - LT travels to Dallas for the first time since 2004. The Bulldogs are 4-2 SU/5-1 ATS in this series though SMU did win the last meeting in '21 39-37 (-11), scoring a 33 yd td pass as time expired. Both teams are under 2nd year HC's. SMU has 16 starters back and are off a 7-6 season, breaking in QB Preston Stone. LT had a 333-4 passing yard edge last week vs

FIU but settled for six fg attempts and only won 22-17. The Bulldogs have yet to win a road game under Cumbie, going 0-7 SU/1-6 ATS last year with five of their losses coming by 20 points or more. SMU was only 1-3 as a HF last year but did go 11-4 as a HF from '19-'21.

PENN ST by 27 over West Virginia - 60th meeting, Penn St leads series 48-9-2 but last time they met was back in 1992. The pressure is on WV HC Neal Brown to win here as he has not won more than 6 games in any season. WVU returns 13 st'rs and have a strong RB room led by CJ Donaldson and they have one of the top OLine's in the Big 12. Expectations are high for Penn St in '23 and they return 16 st'rs but will have a new QB in Drew Allar and they have an excellent 1-2 punch at RB in Singleton and Allen. While Penn St has a slight edge on offense (#13 vs #29) they have a bigger edge on defense (#3 vs #78) and their ST's is #28 while WVU is #109. Penn St is 8-4 ATS vs non-conf foes since 2019 and they only have Delaware on deck so this will not be a look ahead spot and WVU HC Brown is just 2-11 SU against ranked teams and failed to cover 2 of their 3 gms vs ranked foes LY. The line is near 3 td's but we still feel Penn St is the superior team and will win by nearly 4 td's.

SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 3RD

RUTGERS by 10 over Northwestern - N'western won both previous meetings (1-1 ATS), including a 21-7 (-2.5) win the last time these teams met in 2021 & the home team has covered in both previous matchups. The Wildcats dismissed HC Fitzgerald late in the summer. He was replaced by interim HC David Braun, who has never been a head coach. He inherits 12 returning starters and N'western checks in at #67 on our experience chart, but they did Cindy transfer Ben Bryant at QB and he starter 11 gms LY. The Wildcats should be solid defensively, with 8 starters back from a squad that allowed 28 ppg last season. Rutgers has 14 starters back and comes in at #16 on our experience chart. They need more consistency from VHT QB Gavin Wimsatt (PS#7), who has completed less than 50% of his passes each of the last 2 seasons. The Scarlet Knights defense should be improved as they have 8 starters back and have potential NFL draft picks on all 3 levels. Rutgers is 4-0 as a HF the last 2 ssn's and has bowl aspirations this year. This game is essentially a must win if that bowl trip is going to happen, so we think the Scarlet Knights come away with a DD win.

Florida St by 4 over Lsu - Orlando. This game is being played in Camping World Stadium in Orlando, FL. The 'Noles are the #2 most experienced team in the country with 17 starters back and added 29 transfers. Jordan Travis returns after throwing for 3,214 and rushed for 417 (5.1). LSU has 15 starters back including QB Jayden Daniels who threw for 2,913 and rushed for 885. The Tigers will be without DT Maason Smith but he missed all of last year with an injury. FSU controlled the game last year for 55 minutes, led 24-10 until LSU scored 2 td's in the last 4:07 but the Tigers missed the game-tying PAT. Both teams are talented, and the Tigers have legit revenge but we will take the underdog Noles who were clearly the better team last year for the majority of the game.

Oregon St by 12 over SAN JOSE ST - 7th all-time meeting, last one came in 2015 where OSU (-7) trailed 21-14 at HT but shut out SJSt 2H and won 35-21 (+185 yds). SJSt has a game under their belt as they took on another Pac-12 team in USC and they trailed just 21-14 HT and 35-21 3Q but wound up losing 56-28 (-105 yds) but were only -1 first down. QB Corderio threw for 3 td's all to former QB turned WR Nick Nash. Oregon St enters the season ranked for the first time since '13 as they return 13 st'rs including 8 on offense and the Beavers bring in former Clemson QB Uiaalelei. SJSt is now 5-1 ATS in their last 6 games against P5 foes, are 3-1 ATS in their L/4 gms vs ranked foes and are 7-4 ATS as a home dog s/'18. OSU is just 1-5 ATS as an away favorite under HC Smith and SJSt should have a good crowd on hand so we expect the Spartans to hang around.

MONDAY SEPTEMBER 4TH

Clemson at DUKE - Clemson opens on Labor Day for 2nd straight season. Clemson is 10-1 SU/7-4 ATS in this series since '99 including a 4-0 SU/ATS run. They last met in '18 when Clemson won 35-6 (-28'). Duke has the experience edge (#3 vs #63) with 18 starters back but Clemson has 15 back and has one of the best defenses in the country. Clemson's offense will open up under new OC Garrett Riley (Bro of Lincoln) who led TCU's offense to put up 38.8 ppg last year. Duke QB Riley Leonard was impressive last year (2967 pass, 20-6, 699 rush, 5.6) but faced a weak schedule with only four bowl teams. Against 5 common opponents LY, Clemson was +24.8 ppg & +144 ypg while Duke was +5.6 ppg & -16 ypg. We will be releasing our first Monday Night Magic play on Labor Day. 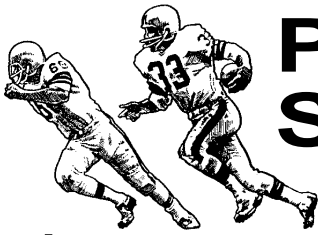
