KEY SELECTIONS

4★ GEORGIA TECH over Bowling Green - 1st meeting. GT is playing their first ever MAC foe. Last week we went against Georgia Tech in our annual free 5★ selection as the Jackets were once again dominated by Clemson. The Tigers led 42-7 3Q and held GT to 146 (2.6) rush yds in their 49-21 (+16) win. BG, at home, fell behind 31-3 vs Miami, OH before scoring td drives of 62, 54 & 74 yds after the game was clearly decided. This will be a much tougher task with a BG defense that has failed miserably to stop the run, allowing 334 (6.4) rush ypg (most in FBS). GT avg 331 (5.9) rush ypg. Both teams come in 0-4 ATS this season but given BG's inability to stop the run, and now facing the option, we feel safe giving the points. BG is also 2-11 as a dog and 7-21 since HC Jinks took over.

FORECAST: GEORGIA TECH by 35

3★ Pittsburgh (+) over UCF - Only prior mtg was the '06 Citrus Bowl (Pitt 52-7 win). Pitt is off a disappointing road loss vs NC. Pitt led 28-21 at halftime, but for the 4th straight gm they struggled in the 2H (10 pts ttl in 4 gms) and lost 38-35 (-3'). UCF gets extra rest off a Fri Night win over FAU. They held a +98 yd edge and allowed 320 (6.4) rushing. Pitt is -4 ypg but have seen a much tougher competition, having faced 3 P5 foes (Penn St, GT & NC). UCF is +191 ypg but have only faced an FCS foe, FAU, and a winless UConn. The Panthers rush for 212 (5.4) ypg and UCF has allowed 239 (4.8). Pitt has a large edge on D and HC Narduzzi is 10-4 as an AD so we will call for the Panthers to pull the outright upset.

FORECAST: Pittsburgh by 3

3★ NOTRE DAME over Stanford - The Cardinal and Irish have played every year since 1997 with ND having a slight 11-10 edge in those games. LY's matchup in Palo Alto was much closer than the 38-20 final as the Irish actually led 20-17 in the 4Q before allowing a TD drive and being forced into a pair of TO's which also resulted in Stanford TD's. The Cardinal stormed back from a 24-7 HT deficit LW in Eugene in the eventual OT victory (UO 524-398 yd edge). The Irish meanwhile throttled WF a week ago on the road behind QB Book who threw for 2 TD's and rushed for 3 more in the 29 pt win (566-398 yd edge). While Stanford is searching for their 2nd consec win in South Bend (17-10 victory in '16), it's hard to lean in their direction here as this is quite the sandwich situation for them following their trip to Autzen and home matchup against Utah on deck.

FORECAST: NOTRE DAME by 9

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Florida St over LOUISVILLE - UL has won the last 2 matchups in this series incl LY when FSU fumbled away a chance to win which led to a Cards getting GW fg. FSU finally got their OFF going in last week's 37-19 (-10) win over Northern Illinois. The 'Noles put up a ssn high 473 yds while holding NIU to a ssn low 221 (6 rush yds allowed!). Now they travel to take on a struggling Louisville team that has been held below 300 yds by all 3 FBS foes. Last week we went against the Cards for a 4★ winner on these pages (3★ LPS) as UL lost 27-3 (+5) at UVA. UL continued their QB musical chairs, starting Malik Cunningham but he was benched in favor of previous starter Jubwon Pass. Neither QB has been effective through the air (comb'd 54%, 3-6 ratio) and against our #45 pass eff D, the struggles will likely continue. UL is on a 5-16 ATS run and we like the 'Noles to continue to improve under HC Taggart.

FORECAST: Florida St by 14

2★ Indiana over RUTGERS - RU covered the F/3 meetings as B10 rivals before being shutout last year 41-0 (+10'). While both enter off losses, IU's was more misleading as they allowed an int return td as well as a td via a fake fg just before the half vs MSU while RU was embarrassed at home vs Buffalo. The Knights have been outscored 149-30 during their 3 game slide! True frosh QB Artur Sitkowski was replaced for a 3rd straight game & may be better served to sit out the rest of the year to preserve his RS. RU is avg just 279 ypg, while IU has held their L/3 foes to their season lows in total yards. Hoosier true frosh RB Stevie Scott was avg 129 rush ypg prior to MSU & RU is allowing 219 (5.7) rush ypg. IU is travelling for the 1st time in 4 weeks with a trip to OSU on deck. Based on LY's result & the way each have played so far this year, we have no problem laying over 3 td's with the Hoosiers.

FORECAST: Indiana by 24

OTHER GAMES

THURSDAY September 26TH

North Carolina vs MIAMI FL - The home team is 5-1 ATS and last year the Tar Heels were nearly 3 td dogs but led 7-6 at half then gave up a 78 yd td pass on 1st play of 2H. They finished with a slight yds edge and lost just 24-19. We picked up a 2★ winner going against the Canes last week (-26') in their 31-17 win over FIU. QB Rosier started but HC Richt gave QB N'Kosi Perry a chance in the 3rd series and he played nearly the entire game (17-25-224-3-1). After a disappointing 0-2 start, NC got in the win column by upsetting Pitt at home last week 38-35 (+3') behind strong performances by QB Elliott (313 yds, 2 td's) and RB Williams (114, 7.1). Miami is +162 ypg vs FBS foes and all 3 of those opponents were held to a ssn low yards. NC is -3 ypg and has allowed 203 (4.5) rush. The Tar Heels are 8-4 as an AD. Miami has covered 8 of their L/9 ACC openers but they do have Florida St on deck.

FRIDAY September 27TH

Memphis vs TULANE - Memphis has dominated this series, winning 11 in a row SU & 12-3 ATS. The Tigers are also 5-0 SU under HC Mike Norvell on regular season Thursday/Friday games following a Saturday game including blowing out Ga State 2 weeks ago. Tulane returns home following B2B road losses at UAB & Ohio St. This will be the lone home game in a 5 week stretch for the Green Wave. Memphis, defended the option 3 weeks ago in their 1 point loss at Navy, holding the Middies to just 3.6 ypc. In last years meeting Memphis held Tulane to just 122 (2.3) and won by 30. Tulane allowed UAB to rush for 269 (4.8) 2 weeks ago & Memphis is avg 310 (8.1) rush ypg, led by Darrell Henderson who has 709 yds & is avg an absurd 12.2 ypc. Tulane is 6-10 as a HD, while Memphis is 4-1 as an AF.

Ucla vs COLORADO - While both teams enter play well rested following an early week off, the start to their respective seasons have been quite different with the Buffs owning a 3-0 mark highlighted by an upset win in Neb and the Bruins winless in the first year under HC Kelly (outscored by 21 ppg). Recent SU history has been in favor of UCLA who owns a 6-1 mark including a 27-23 win a year ago in Pasadena where they had minimal edges in both FD (25-24) and yds (467-434). However, despite losses in 6 out of the previously mentioned 7 matchups, it is worth noting that Colorado is 4-3 ATS against UCLA including a spread winner in that '17 matchup as a 7' pt dog.

SATURDAY September 29TH

BUFFALO by 4 over army - While the HT has the L/4 SU they are just 2-2 ATS with the Bulls covering 2 straight as a DD dog. The last 2 yrs the tm that led at HT & into the 4Q has lost. The Bulls are in new territory as after having just 2 winning ssn's since moving up in 1999, they have started 4-0 including LW's blowout 42-13 win over Rutgers as a 6' pt AF, their first ever vs a Big Ten tm. Much of that success is due to QB Jackson, who is staying healthy as a pocket passer throwing for 263 ypg (61.9%) with a 15-3 ratio. Army is off a heartbreaking 28-21 OT loss to #5 Oklahoma almost pulling the upset as a 30' pt AD. While the Bulls come in at avg 40 ypg, Army held their last 2 foes to ssn low 21 pts in regulation in Hawaii, who avg'd 47 ppg in their other games & OU that came into LW avg'g 50 ppg. We look for the Knights to keep it close here.

COLLEGE MARQUEES 9-5 64% L3W!!!!

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Cincinnati by 21 over CONNECTICUT - Cincy is on a 5-2 ATS run in this series. These two schools are trending in opposite directions as Cincy has already matched their win total of each of the L2Y, while UConn is in year 2 of their rebuild & is getting outscored by an avg of 56-15 vs FBS foes. Cincy does enter of an emotional come-from-behind win over in-state rival Ohio. Trailing 24-7 at HT, they took their 1st lead on RB Michael Warren's 3 yard td run after a 92/13pl drive with 3:24 left & sealed it after an int on 3&GL from the 4 w/under a minute left. While Cincy is avg 426 ypg, they're actually being held to 155 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. UConn however, has a defense loaded with frosh & is allowing foes 212 ypg more than their avg! UConn is 25-15 as a HD & we can't justify backing Cincy by more than 3 td's.

MICHIGAN ST by 21 over Central Michigan - These in-state rivals are only about an hour drive apart. CM actually won here in '09, but in the 3 meetings since has lost by an avg score of 39-8. Due to a struggling offense that was avg just 286 ypg, CM made a change at QB last week in their unimpressive win vs FCS Maine. Tommy Lazzaro made his first career start in place of Tony Poljan, but CM finished w/a season low 177 yards. MSU responded from their loss at AZSt with a 14 point win at Indy. Sparty led 28-7 4Q, but needed a 75 yard td run w/3:17 left to seal it. MSU is allowing just 33 (1.1) rush ypg, so the only way CM will have a chance here is through the air & they've been held to under 200 pass yds in every game. Both are in conference sandwiches. MSU is home for the 1st time in 4 weeks, but CM is 14-4 as an AD. Until MSU proves capable of blowing a team out, we'll set our line at 3 td's.

Northern Illinois by 3 over EASTERN MICHIGAN - EM has opened as the favorite, despite NIU winning 10 straight in this series (7-3 ATS but EM did take the games to OT the last 2 yrs. The Eagles are 3-1 ATS TY incl covering as a 13 pt AD LW at SDSU, losing 23-20 in OT. They lost their MAC opener 35-28 at Buffalo in their only ATS loss (+3). NIU is 0-3-1 ATS but did win their MAC Opener 24-16 (-14) over CM (allowed the back door cover). LW NIU traveled to FSU and only trailed 23-13 (+10) into the 4Q but allowed a 78 yd td pass and lost by 18. While EM has improved NIU is the more experienced team (#40-#85) and should still be the favorite but has opened as the dog.

BALL ST by 7 over kent st - While the HT has won 5 straight this is the first meeting of these cross divisional foes since 2013 a 27-24 Ball St win. While this is KSU's 3rd straight road game and 4th in 5 wks the other 3 were vs P5 foes and the Flashed were 2-1 ATS in those games including LW wk when they only trailed Ole Miss 21-17 late 3Q as a 28' pt AD and easily covered despite allowing the final 17. Ball St covered vs ND losing just 24-16 as a 34' AD but trailed Indiana 31-3 late 3q (+10) and LW could not hold onto a 20-14 4Q lead as they allowed the final 14 to WKU losing by 8 as a 2' pt HF. Ball St is the more experienced team (#33-#107) but new KSU HC Sean Lewis with his Fast Flash offense has KSU believing they can compete with anyone. look for KSU to keep it under the number and an outright upset here would not shock us.

WAKE FOREST by 28 over Rice - This is Rice's 3rd straight road game with a bye mixed in after traveling to Hawaii and Southern Miss (both DD losses) and now they step up in competition. WF gave up 566 yds in last weeks 56-27 (+6') home loss to Notre Dame. Ironically, Rice also allowed 566 yds, but against a much weaker foe in Southern Miss (-304 yds). The Owls look much improved on OFF and are led by RB Esukpa (358, 5.4). WF QB Hartmann was dinged up last week and is a ?. They did get expected starter Kendall Hinton off susp but he mostly played WR. The Deacons avg 267 (4.9) rush. Both tms rank near the bottom of our pass eff D (WF #116, Rice #129) though WF has the most explosive pass OFF. WF does have Clemson on deck but Rice has a much more winnable game vs UTSA on deck themselves.

EAST CAROLINA by 7 over Old Dominion - ODU st'g QB Steven Williams was replaced after just 1 drive vs VT last week & Blake LaRussa responded w/495 (61%, 4-0) pass yds to lead the biggest win in school history. Tied at 35 4Q, the Monarchs got 2 final td drives consisting of 75/8pl & 79/6pl in the L/5:00. ODU's 600 yards was the most ever allowed by a Bud Foster led defense! EC was tied w/USF 4Q before all'g the game deciding td w/10:13 remaining. The Pirates L/3 drives were SOD at the USF 35, a punt & an int. EC finished w/24-9 FD & 256-181 yd edges. EC had been living out of an Orlando hotel s/Sept 12th & finally returned home this week. ODU was expected to be better than the start they got off too this season, while EC followed up their blowout over UNC w/a more than solid performance at USF. ODU is 3-9 as an AD, but EC is just 2-8 as a HF. Tough to make a play with either team here.

BOSTON COLLEGE by 13 over Temple - BC has won the L/5 in this series but they haven't met since 2004. After a disappointing 0-2 start Temple has looked like the team we expected them to be and last week gave us a Thursday Night Marquee winner vs Tulsa 31-17 (-6'). Now they go back on the road where they already own an outright upset as a DD dog vs Maryland. BC had covered 9 straight until last weeks clunker at Purdue where they got caught patting themselves on the back too much after being ranked for the first time since '08. QB Brown hit less than 50%, RB Dillon was held to 19-59 and the Eagles put up their lowest yards since 2016 w/229. Tempe QB Nuttle is a ? and bkp Russo only hit 7-20-112. Whoever starts at QB will face the #26 pass eff D. We will call for the Eagles to bounce back with a DD win but Temple is 14-6 as an AD.

CLEMSON by 17 over Syracuse - Major revenge game here for Clemson. Last year QB Bryant was hobbled and unable to play the 2H. Cuse, playing in front of a raucous home crowd pulled off the outright upset 27-24 (+23'). We hope everyone called in to get their free 5H GOM as we gave our customers an easy winner with Clemson (-16) and they rolled to a 42-7 3Q lead and won by 28 pts. GT came in avg 392 rush ypg but Clem held them to just 146 (2.6). QB Lawrence appears to have gotten a leg up on QB Bryant after throwing 4 td passes last week while playing the majority of reps. Cuse got QB Dungey back in last week's 30 pt win over UConn. The Orange are 4-0 for the first time since 1991 and have yet to trail in a game. The Orange are +137 ypg while Clemson is +253 ypg and have faced much tougher competition. Despite the revenge factor we will lean with Cuse as they've covered all 4 gms this year while Clem is 1-8 as 20+ pt ACC chalk.

APPALACHIAN ST by 28 over South Alabama - 3rd meeting, with the road team winning the previous 2 games. App State continues to look strong this ssn with new QB Zac Thomas under center (750 yds, 74.6% completion rate, 6-1 ratio) and they are off of a 72-7 win against an FCS foe, while SAla dropped to 1-3 SU on the ssn after a 52-35 loss at Memphis, but are 3-1 ATS overall this ssn. SAla was 3-0 ATS as a DD conference underdog last ssn, but the Jaguars are on their 3rd road game in 4 weeks. App State has won their last 9 SBC home game by 26 ppg & is on a 7-0 run ATS overall, so we will side with the home favorite in this one.

DUKE by 7 over Virginia Tech - VT has won all 6 in Durham since joining the ACC with the L/3 being decided by 4 pts or less. Absolutely no one saw the Hokies losing to 0-3 Old Dominion last week. Youth finally caught up with the Hokies D, giving up the most yds under DC Foster (632) and the 495 pass yards was the most VT allowed since 1993. QB Jackson was inj'd (leg, CS) and bkp Ryan Willis (Kansas transfer) threw for 131. Duke is off an easy win over FCS NC Central, making QB Harris 2-0 as a starter but he was inj'd 3Q (CS). Duke has been 4-0 two other occasions under Cutcliffe but has yet to reach 5-0. HC Fuente said he liked his team a lot more when everyone thought they weren't good.

UM by 7 over GEORGIA ST - ULM has won 2 of the 3 prior meetings, but GS got out to a 33-10 lead by the 3Q and held on to win 47-37 on the road. In LY's matchup GS put up a school record 670 total yds. Though GS has a brand new stadium, they have had little success there, going just 2-5 SU since it opened last ssn. The GS offense has also struggled to score pts this ssn, avg'g just 17 ppg through 4 weeks and are off a 34-15 loss to Western Mich. ULM's defense has been a bit of a surprise this year, but the offense is still the strength of this team. The Warhawks trailed Troy 35-7 last week at HT, but rallied in the 2H and lost 35-27. ULM is just 3-5 in their L/8 conf road games ATS & while they appear to be the stronger team, we can't call for them to win by more than a td.

OHIO by 11 over Massachusetts - Despite being former MAC East foes, this is just UMass's 2nd trip here as the teams have met just 3 times with Ohio going 3-0 SU & 2-1 ATS including a 58-50 shootout win LY as a 6 pt AF. After opening at home and having a week 2 bye, this will be the Bobcats only HG in a 49 day period. Ohio is off a disappointing loss to Cinn as they led 21-0 & 24-7 at HT and 30-21 early 4Q before allowing the final 13. This is UMass's 4th road game in 5 wks but they are off a 49-31 win over Charlotte as a 7 pt HF. They were led by rF QB Curtis in his first start (12-18-189, 2 td, 35 rush (2 td)) with their top 2 QB's Andrew Ford & Ross Comis injured. With their status unknown there is no opening line as if neither returns this will be Curtis's first road start. Even if they do, we still look for the Bobcats to win another shootout this year.

KENTUCKY by 3 over South Carolina - Kentucky is on a school record 4 gm win streak over SC (longest streak over SEC East foe not named Vandy) and 3 of those wins were outright upsets incl LY's 23-13 (+5) road win. SC enters off a 37-14 win. The Gamecocks only led 20-14 at halftime but dominated the 2H and finished w/a 534-284 yd edge (L/td came in garbage time). It's time to take Kentucky seriously as they've dominated 2 SEC foes as dogs after last week's impressive 28-7 win over Miss St (+9'). They are 4-0 for the first time since 2008. RB Snell had all 4 td's last week and he now has 375 (6.0) on the season. SC allows 163 (3.9) rush ypg and they held 2 of their 3 foes to their lowest ypg on the season. KY is +148 ypg while SC is +144 ypg. The 'Cats have failed to cover their last 8 as a HF but this is a more talented KY team that is full of confidence.

NC STATE by 2 over Virginia - These two ACC foes L/met in 2015. UVA is 2-18 SU on the ACC road the L6Y. NCST has won their L/2 ACC openers, beating FSU & WF. We used Virginia as our Power Sweep 4★ a week ago on these pages as well as a 3★ LPS. The 'Hoos gave our readers an easy win last week, beating Louisville 27-3 (-5) while holding a 401-214 yard edge. NCST put up 502 yds vs a solid Marshall D last week. QB Finley threw for 377 yards and the Wolfpack held a +178 yd edge. Virginia has our #21 pass eff D led by CB Juan Thornhill. The 'Hoos are +150 ypg and their D has held their L/2 foes to their lowest yards so far. NCST is +132 ypg and QB Finley has compl'd 69% of his passes while the OL has all'd just 2 sks (1.6%). UVA is 4-0 ATS this year and QB Perkins has been impressive (65%, 9-2 ratio) so we will call for the 'Hoos to stay within a q.

AIR FORCE by 6 over Nevada - AF is 3-1 all-time against Nevada, but the last 3 meetings have all been decided by 7 pts or less and all 4 prior matchups have been high scoring (avg final score is 45-39). Last ssn AF ran for 550 yards and dominated time of possession (41:00-19:00) but still needed a game-winning FG to get the 45-42 win. Last week Nevada was off a big home win vs Oregon St and lost 63-44 at Toledo, while AF is off a 10 pt loss at MW foe Utah St where they racked up 323 rush yds and dominated time of possession 44:00-16:00. AF is 2-4 ATS in conf home openers s/2012 but Nevada is just 1-7 SU (3-5 ATS) in conf road games s/2016.

WASHINGTON ST by 7 over Utah - Following a narrow Fri night defeat on the road against the Trojans where they blew a 13 pt HT lead (tying FG blocked w/1:41 left, WSU 435-354 yd edge), the Cougars return to Pullman to take on a Utes squad that's dropped 3 straight for the first time in a series that dates back to 1966. In LY's matchup in SLC, WSU (-1) capitalized on 7 Utah TO's and 7 sacks by their defense in the 33-25 victory (Utah 367-338 yd edge). While the Utes enter this contest with an early bye week and seeking revenge from a disappointing effort a year ago, the Cougars are on a solid 11-2 ATS run at home against P12 foes including a perfect 4-0 mark a season ago (8 pt avg cover).

ARIZONA ST by 28 over Oregon St - Following a 21 pt defeat LW at home against the Wildcats where Arizona had 29-18 FD and 594-238 yd edges, the Beavers head to the desert searching for some payback after falling 40-24 LY in Corvallis (trailed 30-0 Mid 2Q). While the Sun Devils started off the '18 campaign with a pair of home victories against UTSA and Mich St, their first 2 road trips ended in losing fashion with a narrow losses at both SDSU and LW in Seattle where they covered their 12th straight against the Huskies. Despite the 2-gm skid for ASU coming in, they have gone an outstanding 6-1 ATS as a P12 HF dating back to the end of the '14 ssn. With the Beavers having dropped 21 consec road games including the past 8 by 29 ppg, it may be a long day for the visitor in this one.

WASHINGTON by 14 over BYU - While BYU is just 1-3 here, they won the LTH ('08) 28-27 as an 8' pt AF. These tms last met in the '13 Fight Hunger bowl which UW won 31-16 (-3') despite being outgained 473-319. This is BYU's 3rd P12 foe TY as they beat Arizona 28-23 as a 10 pt AD but lost 31-18 to Cal as a 3 pt HF. Washington is in a P12 sandwich her off a closer than expected 27-20 win over Arizona St as a 18 pt HF with a struggling UCLA on deck. Still with BYU already having upsetting a Top 10 tm this year (24-21 over Wisky as a 22' AD) the Cougars will have UW's full attention here especially as a ranked team. Still UW is just 1-3 ATS TY and we expect BYU to keep it under the opening number.

FRESNO ST by 14 over Toledo - Fresno is off of a bye and their last game was a dominant 38-14 win over UCLA (420-270 yard edge), while Toledo just beat a Mountain West team last week, winning 63-44 at home vs Nevada, despite being outgained 582-460 (TOL blk'd punt TD and KR for TD). The last meeting for these two was a 52-17 loss for Fresno at Toledo back in '16, but in '08 Fresno St edged Toledo in a double OT thriller 55-54. Fresno HC Tedford is 6-1 SU at home, with the avg MOV being 34.6 ppg in those 6 home wins. Fresno has the edge in experience and they are on an 18-6-2 run ATS, so makes us feel even better about their chances and we'll take the Bulldogs in this one.

MIAMI OH by 3 over Western Michigan - WMU has won the last 5 meeting by an avg 16 ppg but was just 3-2 ATS in those games and this is the cross divisional foes first meeting since a 2015 WMU 35-13 win as a 27' pt HF. Miami opened the season 0-3 SU & ATS in non-conf play but LW in their MAC opener easily covered 38-23 as a 6' pt AF over MAC East foe BG. WMU opened the season 0-2 SU & ATS but after blowing out a weak FCS foe, kept their momentum going LW with a 34-15 win at Georgia St as a 7' pt AF. Still this is WM's 3rd road gm in 4 wks and Miami does have the big experience edge (#6-#60), which has us slightly leaning with the home team.

Ohio St by 9 over PENN ST - OSU has won 5 of the L/6 meetings SU, but PSU is on a 3-1 ATS series run. While PSU enters on an extra days rest off their blowout win last Friday at IL, the Nittany Lions actually trailed mid 3Q before scoring 42 unanswered in the L/23 minutes. PSU surprisingly all'd 245 (5.4) rush LW, the exact same they gave up at Pitt! Urban Meyer returned to the sidelines last week in the Buckeyes blowout vs Tulane. OSU is avg 599 ypg & has put up the most yards allowed by all 4 of their foes. Entering the season it was believed that new st'g QB Dwayne Haskins would give OSU a dangerous downfield pass threat & he's done just that, throwing for 1,194 (76%, 16-1) yards! While PSU has held 2 of their 4 foes to season lows in yards, they rank just #61 in our PDR. While the scoreboard shows close games the L2Y, the fact is the Buckeyes outgained PSU by a total of 942-559. OSU is on a 5-1 overall ATS run & will win by just under double-digits.

Arkansas St by 7 over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - Ark St is 2-0 against GS since the Eagles joined the Sun Belt. This is the 2nd straight matchup in Statesboro and last year Ark St won 43-25 despite GS rushing for 333 yds, having a 493-381 yd edge and forcing 5 TO's. GS gets this SBC opener after a bye week, but are just 2-6 SU in conf home games s/2016. GS have an edge with their run game as they are gaining 244 rush ypg so far this ssn while Ark St is allowing 219 rush ypg. Ark St enters SBC play 3-1 after they came back in the 4Q to beat UNLV at home 27-20 last week. The Red Wolves are 21-3 SU (17-7 ATS) against Sun Belt foes s/2015 and are 7-3 as an away dog in conf play the last 3 ssn's. The Eagles are an exp'd team this ssn, but we still like the Red Wolves to pick up the road win by at least a TD.

GEORGIA by 28 over Tennessee - Jeremy Pruitt was DC at Georgia from '14-'15 and apparently won't well liked between the hedges. This was a close matchup for 6 straight years with the largest MOV 8 points, until LY's 41-0 (+8) beatdown on the Vols. Georgia enters off a 14 pt win over Mizzou. The Tigers actually held a 159-148 yd edge at halftime despite UGA's 20-7 lead. HC Pruitt got his first taste of SEC play as HC and it was a disaster last week, losing 47-21 (+3) to Florida. At one point the Vols had a 236-224 yard edge yet they trailed 33-6. They didn't punt until mid 3Q, with their drives ending by fumble, int, SOD, safety, fumble, fumble, int. QB Guarantano was inj'd in 2H (CS) and replaced by Stanford grad transfer Kellar Chryst. UGA is +185 ypg and should win this easily and the Vols are on a 3-13 ATS run & 1-6-1 ATS on the road.

NEW MEXICO by 16 over Liberty - First ever meeting. New Mexico is off of a bye and has an edge with the altitude Liberty will be facing. Liberty is also making their furthest trip west in 20 years. As of now NM HC Bob Davie is hopeful starting QB Tevaka Tuioti can return, but bkp Sheriron Jones could be making his 2nd straight start. Liberty won their first game as an FBS team vs ODU, but since then have lost 2 straight to Army and N. Texas by a comb'd score of 85-21. Though the Lobos are on a 4-12 run as a home favorite, Liberty is in their first year as an FBS school and is allowing over 300 rush ypg, which NM's strength under Davie has been their run offense. We will lean with the Lobos here as many factors are in their favor.

AUBURN by 17 over Southern Miss - Last met in 2008. HC Malzahn hasn't fared well in sandwich games, going 3-8 since 2014 and they've got Miss St on deck. At first glance, it appears Auburn dominated Arkansas last week, winning 34-3 (-30). However a closer look shows that they were outgained by 65 yards and finished with just 225 ttl yards (91 rush, 2.5). About 2 TO's, 1 KR td and a blk'd punt that led to a short td drive. Southern Miss got 4 td's from QB Abraham who started despite QB Griggs being reinstated (DNP). The Golden Eagles are +208 ypg but the best they've faced is ULM while Aub is +132 ypg but has faced Wash, LSU & Ark. SM is 5-3 ATS vs SEC foes and has a bye on deck so we'll back the dogs here since Aub is just 5-16-1 as a HF.

TCU by 14 over Iowa St - TCU had won the last 3 meetings in this series by an avg of 32 ppg entering LY. Undefeated & ranked #4, the Horned Frogs were upset & is naturally playing with revenge. While TCU enters off B2B double-digit physical losses vs Ohio St & TX, they more than held their own in both meetings & has held each of their 3 foes to season lows in total yards. Off B2B emotional losses to start the season, in a B12 sandwich, as well as a tragedy that struck the hearts of many in Ames, ISU didn't put Akron away until mid 4Q as Zeb Noland continues to lead the offense, but Kyle Kempt could return here (CS). The Frogs return home for the 1st time in 4 weeks, has a bye on deck & will be rewarded on the scoreboard in a game they should have no problem winning by 2 td's.

ALABAMA by 50 over Louisiana - Bama had their streak of scoring 50+ points end at 3 games last week in their 45-23 (-26) win over A&M. Tagovailoa threw for 387 and 4 td's and has yet to play in the 4Q of a game. The Tide led 45-16 3Q though they only finished with a +131 yd edge. Louisiana dropped their 2nd straight last week, losing at home to Coastal Carolina 30-28 (-3'). The Cajuns have already faced an SEC foe, getting crushed at Miss St 56-10 (+34). Saban tends to take it easy on SBC foes, with an avg score of 42-5 and haven't covered their L/4. Still, we will give a slight lean to Bama who has put up over 500 yds in each of their F/4 (only put up 500 yds 4 times all LY!).

OKLAHOMA by 17 over Baylor - BU is on a 5-2 ATS series run overall & has also covered 7 of the L/8 in Norman. OU was in a predictable flat spot last week & needed OT to get by Army. The Sooners entered the game holding foes to 116 (2.9) rush ypg, but couldn't keep Army's option off the field, allowing 339 (4.3) rush. BU responded to their double-digit loss vs Duke with their best performance of the year over improved Kansas. The Bears appear to be settling on QB Charlie Brewer after beginning the season alternating Jalan McClendon under center & has finished with the most yards allowed by each of their L/2 foes. Despite finishing w/a season low 355 yards last week, OU still avg an impressive 8.9 yds/play. BU HC Matt Rhule is 17-6 as a dog of 7' or more & we'll call for the Bears to keep this game closer than expected.

UTSA by 10 over Utep - The home team is 0-5 SU/ATS. UTSA is favored for the second straight week against a weak opponent. The Miners have now lost 16 straight games SU after last week's 27-20 (+4') loss vs NMST. UTEP actually held a +118 yard edge but gave up a Punt blk td and a fmbt return td. The 429 yards of OFF for UTEP was their most since '16. UTSA is off a 25-21 (-7) win over Texas St. The RoadRunners have yet to put up over 300 yds of OFF and in all 4 games, they put up the lowest amount of yards their opponent's have allowed all ssn. UTSA is on a 1-11 ATS run (8 straight non-covers) while UTEP is on a 3-12-1 ATS run. It's hard to want to lean with either team so we will just take the points.

NEBRASKA by 7 over Purdue - PU is on a 3-1 ATS run in this series & the visitor has covered 4 of the 5 B10 meetings. NU is off to their worst start s/1945! While the Huskers were blown out last week by an angry Michigan team on the road, they did outgain their F/2 foes by an avg of 141 yards! PU entered last week winless, but had outgained all 3 of their foes & routed a Boston College team that was feeling good about itself after being ranked for the 1st time in 10Y. NU got the return of QB Adrian Martinez last week & this is their lone home game in a 4 week stretch with the homecoming crowd on hand. PU is travelling for the 1st time. The Boilermakers are an AF for just the 2nd time in the L6Y (lost at Rutgers LY). NU avg 258 rush ypg their F/2 games & PU all'd 166 rush vs NW & 233 rush vs Mizzou. We'll call for the outright upset.

Texas by 14 over KANSAS ST - The home team has dominated this series of late going 6-0 SU & had covered 5 in a row until LY. KSU is 5-0 SU/ATS in Manhattan between these B12 rivals. After a humbling season opening defeat, TX has won 3 straight including B2B wins over ranked foes for the 1st time s/08 following their victory over TCU (Underdog POW outright win on these pages LW!). The 'Horns held each of those 2 ranked foes (USC was the other) to their season low in total yards. KSU has alternated good & poor performances the L3W. The 'Cats failed to break 100 yds of offense in the 1H of their blowout loss at WV last week & didn't cross midfield until the 3Q. The loss of 9Y OC Dimel appears to have had an effect on an offense that returned 8 starters. The OL with all 5 starters back has underachieved as KSU has already allowed 14 sacks & is avg just 3.9 rush ypc. TX is 6-2 ATS away from Austin & look for RB Keaontay Ingram to find more open running lanes vs 'Cats defense that was gashed on the ground vs Miss St.

TEXAS TECH by 3 over West Virginia - WV has won 4 in a row SU in this series & LY trailed by over 2 td's mid 3Q before scoring 29 unanswered. WV only led KSU 7-0 last week before scoring 2 td's in the L/3 minutes of the 1H and then cruised in the 2H. QB Will Grier continues to impress as he's thrown for 1,117 (75%, 14-3) yards, but TT countered with our #11 ranked PDR. WV is travelling for the 1st time in 4 weeks. A week after his record setting performance vs Houston, TT true frosh QB Alan Bowman threw for 397 (76%) to lead the Red Raiders in a blowout win at OkSt (another outright winner for our Big Dog plays released every Thursday!). TT has finished w/the most yards allowed this season by each of their L/2 foes & is off their most impressive defensive performance of the season. TT has a bye on deck, is 14-8 as a HD & had WV on the ropes in Morgantown LY so we'll call for the outright upset.

NORTH TEXAS by 4 over Louisiana Tech - Both the home team and LT are 5-2 SU/ATS in this series. NT won last year's meeting 24-23 (-4) after rallying from a 10 pt 2Q deficit and the Mean Green finished +100 yds. LT was nearly a 3 td dog but kept it closer than expected vs LSU and actually held a +8 yard edge vs the Tigers. LT trailed 24-21 4Q allowing 2 late td drives. NT is 3-0 ATS this season after avoiding a let down against Liberty last week off their big win over Arkansas. The Mean Green put up over 500 yds of OFF for the 3rd time this year and they are +203 ypg. NT has won their last 9 at Apogee Stadium (6-3 ATS) but HC Holtz gets the most out of his squad and is 11-3 as a dog since 2014.

UAB by 19 over Charlotte - UAB was in an unfamiliar role last year as road chalk vs Charlotte. The Blazers fell behind 17-0 mid 3Q then rallied to tie the game before losing in OT 25-24 (-7). This year UAB is favored again but much more comfortable at home where they've gone 8-0 SU (avg MOV 19.3 ppg). Charlotte enters off a 49-31 (+7) loss at UMass who played w/o their starting QB. The 49ers trailed 49-17 4Q before adding 2 garbage time td's. UAB gets extra rest off a bye. The Blazers avg 477 ypg on the season and avg 280 (5.6) rush ypg. Charlotte has been stout against the run, allowing just 135 ypg (4.1). With Charlotte playing their second straight road game against a revenge minded UAB squad that is 7-0-1 ATS at home, we'll gladly lay the points.

Oklahoma St by 21 over KANSAS - The home team was on a 5-0 ATS run in the series, but the L2Y have ended in a push. Despite 3 straight covers to open the season, we felt confident enough in going against them as part of our 'Big Dogs' & the Pokes were dominated by TX Tech. KU was feeling good after B2B wins, but were sent back to reality in their loss at Baylor last week, being held to just 271 yards. OSU is avg 226 (5.6) rush ypg & KU is allowing 170 (4.7) vs 2 P5 foes. The Pokes are travelling for the 1st time, but will look to rebuild their confidence & should have no problem vs a Jayhawk team that is 1-4 as a HD.

Marshall by 9 over WKU - WKU had their 3 game series win streak snapped by the Herd last year, 30-23 (-10'). MU led that game 30-10 late 3Q then WKU added two 4Q td's. This year Marshall entered as one of the most experienced teams in CUSA (18 returning starters). The Herd enter off a disappointing 37-20 (+6) home loss to NCSU, though they only trailed 30-20 and were driving when QB Green threw a pick 6 to put the game away. WKU has played well despite losing QB Eckels after week 2, nearly upsetting Louisville in a 3 pt loss (+23) then upsetting revenge minded Ball St 28-20 (+2). Davis Shanley got the start last week but it was soph Steven Duncan who finished this time, throwing

for 94 yds and 2 td's. The 'Toppers don't have nearly the athletes that NCSU does so we expect the Herd (7-1 ATS away from home) to win by nearly DD's.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 14 over Florida - It's the Dan Mullen bowl as the HC travels to Starkville to take on his old team. Mullen knows the team well, having recruited almost every player on the Bulldogs but they will be motivated to beat their old coach who left for greener pastures. Florida is off a deceiving 47-21 (-3') win over Tennessee. The Gators forced 6 TO's, and had td drives of 21, 7 & 19 yds and didn't force Tennessee to punt until mid 3Q. Miss St will be hungry coming off their surprising 28-7 (-9') loss at Kentucky. The Bulldogs will have to get their run game going again after being dominated at the LOS last week (outtrushed 226-56!). MSU is still +174 ypg vs 3 FBS foes while UF is -13 ypg. QB Franks has completed just 52.6% passing yet still has a 12-2 ratio and faces our #35 pass eff D. Florida is on a 1-9 run as a dog and are ply'g B2B road gms.

LSU by 20 over Ole Miss - The home team is 5-1 SU/4-2 ATS and Ole Miss is 14-7 ATS in this series. LSU was off their big upset over Auburn last week so it's no surprise they had a subpar performance, beating Louisiana Tech 38-21 (-20). The Tigers were up 24-7 at half with a 258-183 yd edge but LT cut it to 24-21 4Q before LSU added 2 4Q td's (LT 417-409 yd edge). Ole Miss also had a lackluster performance, beating Kent St 38-17 (-28'). The Rebels held a 651-390 yard edge. Last year LSU gashed Ole Miss for 393 (7.1) rush yds. While Ole Miss is better against the run this year, allowing 191 (4.5), they've also given up 505 ypg, 55 more than LY's porous defense. QB Burrow could have his best game yet against our #60 pass eff D. Ole Miss is 0-3 as a home dog under HC Luke while LSU is 4-2 as an AF under Orgeron and on a 9-1 reg ssn run vs FBS foes.

TROY by 17 over Coastal Carolina - In last ssn's meeting Troy outgained CC 381-258, but dominated the scoreboard 42-17 thanks to 2 KR touchdowns in the opening quarter by freshman Marcus Jones. CC is on a 7-3 ATS run in the L/10 gms and are 3-1-1 as an away underdog in SBC play. Troy just avoided a lull last week against ULM after beating Big 10 foe Nebraska the week prior, winning 35-27 (were up 35-7 at HT and held on to win). Troy HC Neal Brown is 12-5 SU at home, but just 4-7 ATS as a home favorite in SBC play. CC has shown improvement in year 2 in the FBS (3-1 record, scoring 37.5 ppg) but are giving up 420 ypg and 30.5 ppg and still lack the overall depth to compete with the big boys in the SBC. Troy has looked strong after falling in Week 1 to Boise and we like the Trojans to get this game by over 2 td's.

Usc by 10 over ARIZONA - The Trojans have won 5 consec matchups in this series by 13 ppg. In their home meeting with the Wildcats a year ago, USC jumped out to a 21-6 HT lead en route to a 14 pt victory (642-380 yd edge). The Trojans were extremely fortunate to end their 2-gm skid last Fri night against WSU as they needed a late FG block to preserve the 3 pt win (outgained 435-354 and trailed by DD in 2H). The Wildcats meanwhile dominated the Beavers LW in Corvallis behind a defense that allowed 21 pts and 231 ypg below their ssn avg. With Arizona still trying to get solid footing with new HC Sumlin in Tucson, we'll back the Trojans in this one as they've covered 7 of their past 10 as an AF including a 34 pt victory (-10) here just 2 seasons ago.

Boise St by 23 over WYOMING - Both teams are off of a bye. Boise has had Wyoming's number, winning 11 of their 12 prior meetings SU. But the lone win for the Cowboys came the last time these teams met in Laramie 2 ssn's ago. Last year WY was looking like they may get their 2nd straight win over Boise, as they led 14-10 after 3Q. However, Boise would score 14 unanswered pts in the 4Q to win on the blue turf 24-14. WY is 12-4 SU at home s/2016 and are 8-3 s/2015 as a home dog in conf play. Boise is off of a 44-21 loss to Oklahoma St, where they were only outgained by 8 yds (422-414) but had 2 punts blk'd that led to TD's for Ok St. WY's defense is only allowing 356 ypg & 25.5 ppg, but those are both down from last yr and they do have injuries to some key players on that side of the ball. Boise is 7-4 s/2015 as an away favorite in conf play and we like the Broncos to pick up a blowout win here.

Hawaii by 10 over SAN JOSE ST - This series has been close one over the years, with Hawaii holding a slight 20-19-1 edge over the Spartans. UH though has dominated this series as the road team, going 7-1 SU s/1999. UH QB Cole McDonald leads the FBS w/ 1,759 pass yds and has a 20-1 ratio and should have a field day against a SJSU defense that is allowing 392 pass ypg this season. SJSU does have the edge of being off of a bye, but are 4-6-1 as a home dog s/ joining the MW. SJSU has struggled to find a QB to stick with this ssn, but did their best against Oregon, losing 35-22. UH is just 1-8 as a favorite in MW play, so we'll lean with the home dog.

Michigan by 10 over NORTHWESTERN - NW enters fresh off a much needed bye following B2B home losses to Duke & Akron (wait, what?). The 'Cats actually outgained both. After losing their opener at Notre Dame, UM has won 3 straight, all by over 3 td's while holding 3 of their 4 foes to their season low in yards. NW all'd 202 (8.1) rush in their opener, but hasn't allowed over 100 yards on the ground in a game since. The Wolves had bulletin board material leading up to their blowout last week, but NW is too smart to let that happen here. UM is just 7-15 as an AF & has already lost outright in that role this season. NW has covered each of the L3Y off their regular season bye and we feel will do so again this year.

† Texas a&m by 17 over Arkansas - A&M has won 6 straight in this series which features 2 new coaches. Three of the L/4 have been decided by 7 pts or less but that's unlikely given Arkansas' struggles. HC Fisher has A&M playing well, having covered vs both Clemson (+88 yds) and Bama (-131 yds) in the last 3 weeks. If you looked at Ark's box score last week at Auburn, you would swear it would have been a close game, as Ark held a 290-225 yard edge, yet the Hogs couldn't even keep the game within the 30 point line! John Chavis has Ark's D playing well, allowing just 347 ypg & 88 (2.7) rush ypg. Chavis was A&M's DC from '15-'17 so he knows the personell. A&M has covered all 4 this year but we still believe Ark is better than their record suggests.

Oregon by 7 over CALIFORNIA - While the Ducks are on an 8-1 run in this series overall including a 7-2 ATS mark, they did drop a 2OT contest on a Friday night in Berkeley back in '16 (Cal 636-450 yd edge, led 31-14 at HT). Speaking of OT, the Ducks dropped their matchup in extra time a week ago in Eugene in a contest that they led 24-7 in and were at the Stanford 1-yd line going in for yet another score (Cardinal ret'd an 80-yd fumble for a TD to turn the tide in their favor!). The Bears meanwhile are sitting at 3-0 on the year with extra rest following an early season bye. Despite the situational edge, we'll be siding with an angry flock of Ducks by a small margin here as the favorite in the series has covered 7 of the past 8!

4★ NEW ENGLAND over Miami - Following a dismal outing LW in DET where they were held to just 10 pts, 12 FD's and 209 yds, the Patriots return home having lost 2 of their first 3 gms for the 1st time s/2012. They now welcome a Dolphins squad that surprisingly moved to 3-0 a week ago against OAK behind an outstanding 4Q from WR Wilson who threw (52 yds) and caught (74 yds) TD's (3★ LP Winner on MIA). That impressive beginning to the season for the Dolphins could very well end here however as they've failed to cover 8 of their past 9 as a DIV AD. With the Patriots winning 9 consec matchups outright (7-2 ATS) in Foxboro by 18 ppg, there's no question which way we're leaning in this one. **FORECAST: NEW ENGLAND by 18**

3★ Seattle over ARIZONA - Three yrs ago the Seahawks & Cardinals were fighting for NFC supremacy w/a 23-9 combined mark. This year they sit at a combined 1-5 on the year. The lone victory for the two came LW by SEA who held DAL to just 13 pts while forcing 3 TO's (3.5★ Top Play LP Winner on Under 41). ARZ meanwhile fell in the desert for the 2nd time in 3 wks with CHI storming back from an early 14-0 deficit (outgained 316-221). While both tms have had historically vast success in their home venue, the surprising stat of the wk shows that the visitor is actually on a 6-0-1 SU/ATS run! Although ARZ would love to see rookie QB Rosen cash a victory in his 1st career start (came off the bench for the ineffective Bradford LW), we'll call for SEA to get the job done in Glendale once again. **FORECAST: SEATTLE by 10**

OTHER SELECTION

2★ Cleveland over OAKLAND - The Baker Mayfield era has begun much faster than many thought following a spectacular outing LW against the Jets where he hit on 17-23 passes for 201 yds after replacing Tyrod Taylor due to inj (turned a 14-0 deficit into a 21-17 victory, Browns were favored at home for the 1st time since 2015). They now head to the West Coast to take on a Raiders team that blew their 3rd consec HT lead LW in the heat & humidity of Miami (3★ LP Winner on the Dolphins). While the Raiders are back inside the "Black Hole" and needing a win after a rough 0-3 start, this isn't the same CLE squad that's on just a 7-15 ATS mark as an AD. With the Browns being just a handful of FG misses away from being undefeated on the season, we'll go ahead and call for the outright road upset. **FORECAST: CLEVELAND by 3**

OTHER PLAYS

Minnesota at LA RAMS - Thursday - Huge early season matchup in the NFC between a pair of DIV winners from a year ago. The Rams remained undefeated on the year LW in the "Battle of Los Angeles" with the Chargers as they surpassed the 500 yd offensive mark for the 1st time since 2006. The Vikings meanwhile were clearly looking ahead to their trip to LA as they were a no-show at home LW against the struggling Bills who jumped out to a 27-0 HT lead while forcing MIN into 3 TO's. In LY's meeting in MIN, the Vikings (-2) scored the game's final 24 pts in the 17 pt victory (27-15 FD and 451-254 yd edge). **With both squads still posting solid ATS marks coming in with a combined 21-7 run, check back on Thursday as we'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

INDIANAPOLIS by 3 over Houston - The losing woes for the Texans continued a week ago at home (9 straight defeats) as the winless Giants came into town and escaped with a 5 pt victory (HOU 427-379 yd edge, 2-0 TO deficit). They now head up to IND to take on a Colts squad that came up just short in their upset bid against the Eagles w/PHI getting the GW TD w/3 min remaining (Eagles 379-209 yd edge). In their 2 matchups from a year ago that saw both Andrew Luck and Deshaun Watson on the sidelines with inj, the Colts earned a pair of victories including a 9 pt victory (-5) in the ssn finale. While IND was once a dominant force inside of the AFC South with a 15-2-1 ATS mark from '12-'14, those numbers have dipped to 6-11-1 ATS since. However, with the fact that the Texans have failed to cover 8 of their L/9 inside of the DIV, we'll give the nod to the home team in this matchup.

ATLANTA by 3 over Cincinnati - Following their 2nd consec home contest inside of their DIV a week ago against the Saints where they dropped a 43-37 OT shootout (QB Ryan 374 yds & 5 TD), the Falcons host a Bengals squad that has done relatively well against the NFC with a 24-14 ATS mark. However, CIN did suffer their 1st loss of the '18 campaign LW at CAR as (4★ Newsletter Winner on CAR) QB Dalton was forced into 4 int's. With the Bengals still on a 7-3 ATS run overall dating back to LY and ATL clearly not focused on non-conf matchups in recent seasons (failed to cover 12 of their past 16 vs the AFC), we'll take the points in this one as CIN can go all out with a pair of home matchups on the horizon.

GREEN BAY by 14 over Buffalo - While the season of despair was expected to continue last week in MIN, it was the Vikings that looked like the team that was outscored by 55 pts over the 1st 2 wks (BUF 1st 17+ dog to win outright since 1995!). Rookie QB Allen was spectacular in his 1st career road start as he threw for a TD and rushed for 2 more (held MIN to just 6 pts & 292 yds). BUF is back on the road again this week in Lambeau to take on a Packers team that dropped their 1st game of the ssn LW in D.C. as the Redskins jumped out to a 28-10 HT lead in the eventual 14 pt victory (GB outgained 386-340). While the Bills have done well in recent years with an 8-1-1 ATS mark against the NFC and the line is fairly elevated, going against a GB squad that's gone 13-5 ATS as a HF isn't a wise decision.

DALLAS by 6 over Detroit - The Cowboys were part of yet another 3.5★ LP Under Winner LW against SEA in a game that the Seahawks won by a 24-13 score. The Lions meanwhile head South following a huge SNF win over the Patriots where their defense held Tom Brady and company to just 10 pts and 209 yds. In their most recent matchup back in '16, the Cowboys earned a 42-21 win behind a 3 TD performance from QB Prescott (375-319 yd edge). With DET on just a 5-11 ATS mark as a NDIV AD and the Cowboys defense allowing just 18 ppg and 281 ypg on the year, we'll call for the home team to get back on track in this one.

JACKSONVILLE by 10 over NY Jets - While the Jets jumped out to a 14-0 lead last Thur in CLE, they were unable to hold on late following the Browns inserting QB Mayfield into the lineup (CLE 323-268 yd edge). The Jaguars meanwhile dropped a surprising home matchup at home against the Titans as nearly a 10 pt favorite (held to just 6 pts, 12 FD's and 236 yds). In their Wk 4 meeting of a year ago in NY, the Jaguars came in following their trip to London and fell short in OT as a 3' pt favorite (Jets 471-311 yd edge!). With the Jets posting just a 7-17 ATS mark as a NDIV AD and JAX looking for revenge, we have no problem laying the points in this one.

CHICAGO by 4 over Tampa Bay - The Bears return to Soldier Field following a come-from-behind win over the Cardinals (trailed 14-0 in 2Q) as their defense allowed just 13 FD's and 221 yds). They now welcome a Bucs squad that is off to a 2-0 start as of presstime (MNF vs PIT) with bkp QB Fitzpatrick (409 ypg, 8-1 ratio) slinging the ball at an alarming rate. In their Wk 2 matchup of a year ago, the Bucs were able to claim a 29-7 victory (-6) thanks in part to 4 TO's by the visiting Bears (TB 311-310 yd edge). While it appears that Fitzpatrick could continue to lead the Bucs

offense despite the return of Winston from susp, they are just 2-7 ATS prior to their bye week. With CHI having a disruptive defensive unit led by the combo of LB's Mack and Smith, we'll fade in their direction as they been the polar opposite prior to their week off with a 7-3 ATS mark. **Philadelphia by 6 over TENNESSEE** - Following a come-from-behind 4 pt win a week ago against the Colts with QB Wentz back center (255 yds, 1-1), the Eagles are back in non-conf action again here boasting a 12-4-1 ATS mark against the AFC. While TEN was able to pick up a victory 2 wks ago in Nashville against the Texans, the Titans had a lot of smoke & mirrors involved (fake punt for a TD, outgained 437-283). However, their defensive performance LW in JAX was outstanding as they delivered the outright upset as a 9' pt dog (QB Mariota 12-18 for 100 yds off the bench for Gabbert). With TEN on just a 6-14 ATS run as a HD and the defending champs continuing to click with their franchise QB back from injury, we'll call for the Eagles to improve upon their 11-5-1 ATS run. **LA CHARGERS by 13 over San Francisco** - Following a rough outing LW in Arrowhead against the Chiefs where they lost franchise QB Garoppolo to a ssn-ending ACL injury, the 49ers are back on the non-conf road once again here as they head South to take on the Chargers. In LW's "Battle of LA" with the Rams, the Chargers were gashed on the defensive side of the ball by allowing 35 pts, 33 FD's and 521 yds. With CJ Beathard (1-4 record as starter) expected to re-gain the role under center after being benched in favor of Garoppolo at the end of LY, the Chargers should have no problem getting back on track and going out all here with another home matchup on the horizon against the Raiders.

New Orleans by 6 over NY GIANTS - The Saints head to NY after an OT shootout victory LW in ATL that saw QB Brees record over 400 tll yds and 5 TD's. Following a disappointing effort in DAL and an upset victory a week ago in HOU, the Giants return home for the 1st time since the opening week of the ssn where they nearly upset the Jaguars (5 pt defeat). With the Giants having contests against CAR, PHI and ATL on deck and the Saints covering 5 straight as a NDIV AF while claiming 4 of the past 6 in this series, we'll ride with them here as they look to keep pace with the Bucs atop the NFC South standings.

The Steelers meanwhile sit at 0-1-1 as of presstime with their MNF matchup against the Bucs yet to be determined (PIT on a 1-7 ATS run). **In a series that has seen 9 of the past 13 games decided by 4 pts or less, check back on Sunday after 11am EST for tonight's Marquee Winner!**

Kansas City at DENVER - MNF - Following their first defeat of the ssn LW in BAL where their offense couldn't get clicking (just 293 yds), the Broncos return home to take on a Chiefs squad that has earned a season sweep in each of the past 2 years (4-0 ATS, 10 ppg). While Patrick Mahomes (NFL record 13 TD passes through 3 gms!) has become a household name to NFL fans so far this year during their 3-0 start that included an 11 pt win LW in Arrowhead against the 49ers, his lone action of his rookie campaign did come LY in the finale at "Mile High" as he connected on 22-35 for 284 yds and an int. While KC has some outstanding spread runs heading into their DIV showdown (7-0 overall run, 16-6 as an AF), it will be interesting to see how the Broncos handle being a DIV HD for the first time since 2011!
