KEY SELECTIONS

4★ Nebraska over COLORADO - NU is in revenge mode against their former B12 rival after allowing the GW td w/1:06 remaining last year and seeing QB Martinez inj'd by having his ankle twisted in a pile up. This is CU's home opener and they enter with an extra day of rest/prep following their 52-31 (-13) Rocky Mountain Showdown win last Friday. The Huskers had won 5 of 7 road openers, but enter '19 having lost B2B SU. NU was tested LW and survived a scare from South Alabama as they won 35-21 (-35) despite getting outFD'd 19-15 & out'd 314-276. CU is 0-4 as a HD, while NU is 22-8 ATS away from Lincoln & is on a 7-1 ATS run. We'll chalk up last week's poor outing to looking ahead here and have no problem backing the 'Huskers by nearly 2 td's. **FORECAST: Nebraska by 13**

3★ Texas A&M (+) over CLEMSON - Clemson gets what will likely be their toughest test of the season. A&M nearly upset the eventual Nat'l Champs LY. The Aggies held a 501-413 yd edge in a 2 point loss (+12). Last week Clemson beat a Georgia Tech team in the midst of a scheme transition. RB Etienne went for 205 (17.1) in the 52-14 (-37) win but Tigers' backers didn't secure the cover until K Potter hit a 51 yd fg with 6:11 left. A&M led an experienced Texas St squad 41-0 (-34) until the Bobcats got a td with 0:36 left and TXSt had just 135 yds until that final drive. Jimbo Fisher is 2-0 here as a double-digit dog. Clemson is on a 9-1-1 ATS run but A&M won't be intimidated by Death Valley, having traveled to Bama and Auburn last year. Kellen Mond threw for 430 yards against Clemson's D LY and that was when the Tigers had 4 future NFL Dlinemen. A&M has 7 starters back on offense and we expect A&M will give them their best shot. **FORECAST: CLEMSON by 10**

3★ Army (+) over MICHIGAN - These programs haven't met on the gridiron s/62, but UM did host Air Force in '17 and held their option offense to 186 yards below their season average. The Wolve's have a bye on deck and had a tougher than expected time against Middle Tenn LW. New OC Gattis' #Speed-InSpace mantra needs some work as the offense failed to show any explosiveness, but the D did allow just 67 (2.4) rush. Army also had a tougher than expected game and enters with an extra day of rest/prep following their 14-7 (-21) win over Rice last Friday. Army is on a 11-6 ATS run vs FBS foes. The Black Knights have big expectations this year and were able to stay within a td vs powerful Oklahoma squad LY and should be able to keep this game close as well. **FORECAST: MICHIGAN by 15**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Rutgers (+) over IOWA - This is the B10 opener for each. RU is making their first ever trip to Iowa City and this is just the 2nd all time meeting (L/mtg '16). We upgraded our 2★ on these pages on the Knights to our top weekly LPS 4★ and with new starting QB McClane delivered a 48-21 (-16) win over UMass last Friday. RU has a bye on deck, but has struggled in road openers, having lost 4 straight by 30 ppg. IO enters off a blowout 38-14 (-23) win over Miami, Oh, but the win could prove costly as NFL caliber LT Jackson was inj (CS) and they have rival IOSt on deck. IO is 8-18 as DD B10 chalk, while RU is on a 6-0 ATS run. The Knights ended LY falling at Wisconsin by 14 and at Michigan St by just 4 so have shown the capability of keeping this game tighter than expected. **FORECAST: IOWA by 12**

2★ Miami, FI over NORTH CAROLINA - Two teams trending in opposite directions. The 'Canes have won 6 of the last 9 meetings. LY Miami was out FD'd 24-14 and only held a 354-329 yd edge but 8 NC TO's led to a 47-10 win. The 'Canes are 6-1 SU/ATS in 'true' road openers. NC rallied for a 24-20 (+11) outright upset win over S Carolina in the return of Mack Brown. True Frosh QB Howell threw for 245 yards and both of his td passes came in the 4Q. Miami got a bye week to work on their Oline issues after giving up 10 sacks vs Florida. Expect a much better performance and remember Miami hung with #8 Florida until the end and were only -3 yds and +3 FD's. The 'Canes have a big edge on Defense and ST's and we expect an improved offensive effort off the bye. **FORECAST: Miami, FI by 10**

FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 6TH

Wake Forest vs RICE - Last year Rice was an over-traveled team, having gone to Hawaii, Southern Miss then flying to the east coast in a 4 week span. WF had just fired their DC after B2B losses. The Deacons scored 6 td's in 7 poss plus a fumble return td and led 42-3 at half. They won 56-24 (-27). Rice put up a valiant effort last week as 3 td dogs in a in a 7 pt loss at Army. QB Wiley Green threw for just 62 yds and Rice managed just 243. WF got the GW td with 1:07 left vs Utah St last week for a 38-35 win (-4). QB Jamie Newman threw for 401 yards. WF has talent and experience edges (#33 vs #113) but Rice has covered 6 straight as Dogs. WF has North Carolina on deck and they are 0-3 as an AF under Clawson and 2-8 ATS vs non Power-5 foes.

BOISE ST vs Marshall - These two last met back in the 1994 1-AA Semi Finals with Boise St winning 28-24. LW the Herd cruised over FCS VMI 56-24 (-40). Boise had their game moved to Tallahassee due to Hurricane Dorian, trailed 31-13 mid 2Q then scored the final 23 points while holding FSU to 68 2H yards. The Broncos got 407 pass yards from true frosh QB Hank Bachmeier and they held the 'Noles to just 99 rush yds (3.5). Boise has won 17 straight home openers but they've failed to cover in 3 of the last 4. Marshall is just 3-17 in road openers (7-13 ATS) but they've covered the last 3. Marshall has the experience edge (#11 vs #81) and the Herd are 11-4-1 as an AD while Boise is 16-34 as a HF.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 7TH

PITTSBURGH by 8 over Ohio - The last meeting was back in 2005 when Ohio pulled out a 16-10 win (+14). Pitt enters off a loss in a crucial home ACC meeting with Virginia 30-14 (+2). Kenny Pickett completed 47% vs Virginia's talented secondary (#7 in our PDR last year). He should find more room to throw against a Bobcats D that finished #88 LY. Ohio led FCS Rhode Island 41-13 late 4Q last week before the Rams added a garbage time td. A loss here for Pitt could mean a 0-4 start with Penn St and UCF on deck so don't expect them to look ahead. Ohio is 8-2 as an AD but Pitt is 3-1-1 as a HF and they have a talent edge so we will give them a small lean.

VIRGINIA TECH by 34 over Old Dominion - Major revenge factor here with Virginia Tech who lost last year as 4 td chalk to an ODU team that entered 0-3. VT opened with a disappointing 35-28 (-4) loss at BC. They actually held +10 yd & +11 FD edges but had 5 TO's incl 3 int's from QB Willis. ODU needed a late rd run from Lala Davis and barely beat FCS Norfolk St 24-21 (-27). Now they get a hungry Hokies team that only has Furman on deck. VT has huge an edge in experience (#42 vs #128), plus significant talent edges on offense and defense. There's no way VT doesn't take this seriously and Fuente is 9-5 as a HF so it's Hokies all day.

Uab by 4 over AKRON - First meeting. Akron has never beaten a non-conf FBS foe in Infocision Stadium (0-9 SU/2-7 ATS), losing by an avg 20.2 ppg. UAB had an underwhelming performance last week, barely edging out FCS Alabama St 24-19 (-39). The Blazers put up just 290 yards and were shutout in the 2H. Akron also had a rough opener, getting crushed by Illinois 48-3 and getting out-gained 401-192. Akron has the experience edge with 10 starters back while UAB has just 7 (#87 vs #127). The Blazers have lost 13 straight road openers (4-9 ATS) while Akron is just 8-22 as a home dog the last 10 years. The difference here could come down to coaching and UAB has a large edge there with Bill Clark so we will call for UAB to win by under a touchdown.

PURDUE by 9 over Vanderbilt - These programs haven't met s/42. This is the home opener for PU and they enter with an extra day of prep/rest following their emotional 34-31 (-11) loss at Nevada last Friday, allowing a 56 yd fg with no time left (Big dog winner! Our Big Dog plays are available every Wednesday for \$12). We cashed our Saturday 4★ LPS side going against Vandy in their 30-6 (+22) home loss vs UGA. The 'Dores have a bye on deck. The Boilmakers have TCU on deck. PU HC Brohm is on a 30-19 ATS run and is 14-8 as home chalk. After last weeks upset loss PU needs a win here and will do so just under DD's.

Syracuse by 8 over MARYLAND - These former ACC rivals last met in '14. New MD HC Locksley had a successful debut, with an easy win over FCS Howard last week led by VT trans QB Jackson and plenty of backups. While the Terps began the season with B2B home games, 'Cuse is on the 2nd of B2B away games. Orange QB DeVito showed off his cannon arm LW and MD only had to defend 19 pass attempts so haven't had to deal with a high caliber opposing QB. MD is on a 12-20 ATS run & is 3-20 ATS off a SU win, while 'Cuse is on a 13-6 ATS run. We'll call for the Orange to win by just over a td.

MISSOURI by 14 over West Virginia - Mizzou has won 13 straight home openers, however 9 were vs FCS foes and none were over P5 foes. This is WV's road opener and their 1st true non-conference away game s/14. The Tigers enter angry following their upset 37-31 (-16) loss at Wyoming. Mizzou finished w/28-16 FD & 537-389 yd edges, but couldn't stop the run, allowing 297 (7.1). WV was tied with FCS James Madison 4Q but were able to survive in new HC Brown's debut. The Mountaineers were held to 34 (1.4) rush. The Tigers are on a 13-7 ATS run in the regular season & are 6-2 as home chalk. We expect this game to finish at the line.

OHIO ST by 17 over Cincinnati - Cincy HC Fickel started 50 games at Ost and spent 15Y as a coach in Columbus, including interim HC in '11. In the last meeting ('14) the Bearcats trailed by less than a td before allowing the final 17 points. The Buckeyes got off to a fast start LW leading 28-0, 1Q in their 45-21 (-27) win over FAU and have a trip to Indy for their B10 opener on deck. Cincy enters with a couple extra days of prep/rest following their 24-14 (-3) win vs UCLA, allowing just 218 yards & 12 FD's. The Bearcats are 8-15 ATS vs non-conference foes & on a 3-5 ATS run vs FBS foes. We would feel comfortable backing the 'Cats if they hadn't fallen flat in their last marquee game at UCF LY.

KANSAS ST by 22 over Bowling Green - The Chris Klieman era got off to a successful start as KSt was able to easily handle FCS foe Nicholls St last week. BG also has a new HC in Scot Loeffler and also got an easy win over an FCS foe (Morgan St). This is the Falcons road opener, but they do enter off a couple of extra days prep/rest after playing last Thursday. The 'Cats ran for 361 (6.2) LW and the Falcons allowed 281 (5.9) rush LY. BG is 1-10 as a DD non-conf dog. BG is 45-26 ATS on the road, while KSt is 3-9 as home chalk. We're not ready to back the 'Cats laying this many points just yet.

UTAH by 17 over Northern Illinois - LY's 17-6 Utah win (-11) was the only prior mtg. The Utes only led 7-6 with under 5 min left but did finish with a 355-230 yd edge. The Utes are 24-4 in home openers and are off a Thursday win over instate rival BYU, 30-12 (-6). They only had a 362-300 yd edge but were +3 TO's (2 IR TD's). Including bowls, Huskies have lost 12 of their L/13 non-conf away gms (only win at Nebraska in '17). They are off a 24-10 win over the FCS's #15, Illinois St (-6) in HC Hammond's debut. While NIU was able to keep it close at home LY, they are on the road against a Utah team that has extra rest & who will not be looking past them with just Idaho St on deck but NIU is an experienced team (#12 in FBS) and should keep this within 3 td's.

Usf by 7 over GEORGIA TECH - GT is in revenge mode after squandering a 4Q lead last year. The Yellow Jackets, who enter with an extra day of rest/prep following their blowout loss to defending Nat'l Champ Clemson last Thursday, have won 12 straight home openers and has FCS The Citadel on deck. USF has won 3 straight road openers, including Syracuse in '16 and Illinois last year and 4 straight non-conference road games. The Bulls have FCS South Carolina St on deck. After avg their lowest ppg s/14 LY, the Bulls hired a new OC, but the offense looked lost LW vs Wisconsin (157 yds, lowest s/13). USF is 7-0 ATS in game 2 & is 23-10 as an AD, while GT is on an 0-4 ATS run and is 11-17 as chalk. As bad as USF looked last week, teams improve the most from week 1-2 & we will call for the upset vs a team that is changing schemes.

Tulsa by 7 over SAN JOSE ST - TU is in a tough situation as they're in a Michigan St/Oklahoma St sandwich and is on the 2nd of B2B away games (2,573 miles travelled). While SJSt is on their 2nd straight home game, had an extra day of rest/prep, and has a bye on deck. Something has to give as the Hurricane has lost 13 straight regular season non-conference road games, while SJSt has failed to win a non-conference home game vs an FBS foe s/12! While TU was held to 102 yds & 8 FD's last week, Michigan St has arguably the best D in the nation. SJSt is 16-27 as a dog & the SU winner in SJSt games is 49-12 ATS, while TU is 19-10 ATS away. We have this game right at the line.

WISCONSIN by 24 over Central Michigan - 1st meeting. This is the road opener for CM and they enter with an extra day of prep/rest following their win over FCS Albany last Thursday, but has their MAC opener on deck. UW has a bye on deck and this is their home opener. The Badgers look in peak form following their 49-0 shutout over what was supposed to be an offensively improved USF team, holding the Bulls to 157 yds & 9 FD's! CM is 5-0 as a dog of 20+ points & is 16-5 as an AD, while UW is 5-14 ATS in their F/3 home games & 2-6 as chalk of 20+ points. While we feel the Badgers will win comfortably, it's hard to ignore their ATS struggles in this role.

APPALACHIAN ST by 28 over Charlotte - Two new HC's are looking for their first win over an FBS foe after both beat FCS foes LW. App St dominated UC last year 45-9 with a 434-203 yd edge. USF transfer Brett Kean got the start for UC LW but it was LY's starter, Chris Reynolds who got the majority of the action, throwing for 136 yds. App St holds the experience edge (#9 vs #78) w/16 starters back incl QB Thomas. The 49ers will need to get RB LeMay going after he finished with just 35 yards LY but he will find it tough sledding against the Mountaineers D that allowed just 126 (3.4) LY. App St has covered their L/6 vs non-conf foes while UC is 4-12 ATS vs non-conf foes.

MISSISSIPPI ST by 12 over Southern Miss - Miss St won the two most recent meetings in '14 and '15 but SM did get the cover LTH. MSt had 7 players suspended for their 38-28 win (-19). QB Stevens threw for 236 yds and 2 td's in his first start. SM enters off a 38-10 (-26) win over FCS Alcorn St. SM has 16 starters back incl 10 on offense. Their defense allowed just 19.8 ppg LY and Stevens will get tested by the Golden Eagles pass D (#22 LY in our PDR, 53%, 13-14) that brought back 3 starters. SM is 5-2 as an AD and they've covered their L/4 road openers including an upset over Kentucky in '16 and a closer than expected loss at Auburn LY where they held the Tigers to 341 yds. HC Moorhead is 5-1 as a HF but they've got Kansas St on deck and SM is capable of keeping this close.

Illinois by 15 over UCONN - Not only is this the 1st meeting, but this is IL's 1st trip to the New England area. While IL has lost 15 of their L17 road openers, they did beat Rutgers in that role last year. The Illini hasn't won a non-conference away game s/07! UConn enters with an extra day of prep/rest following their 24-21 win over FCS Wagner last Thursday and has a bye on deck. The Huskies had 60 rush attempts with RB Mensah accounting for 36 carries. New IL QB Peters looked comfy in his Illini debut as they had no trouble dispatching Akron 42-3 (-18). IL is 25-39 as chalk & is on a 10-19 ATS run. We can only back IL by just over 2 td's so we'll call for UConn to keep it closer than expected.

UNLV by 5 over Arkansas St - 3rd mtg, home team is 2-0. These trms met last ssn and in the rain AST came away with a hard-fought 27-20 win. AST is off a 37-30 loss at home vs SMU and could still be w/o their HC for this gm. UNLV had little trouble in Week 1, as they 56-23 over FCS Southern Utah and dual-threat QB Rogers had 258 td yds. UNLV will likely go all-out to win this gm as their other 2 non-conf gms are at N'Western & at Vandy. AST QB Bonner threw for 324 yds & 4 TD's last week in their opener last wk, but now makes his 1st career road start. AST is just 3-12 ATS in non-conf gms the L4Y, while the Rebels are 11-6 ATS under HC Sanchez in non-conf gms. AST has the better DEF and will keep them in this game, but we'll back the home team here as the pressure is on Sanchez to reach a bowl gm, and this win would go a long way.

BAYLOR by 17 over Utsa - These programs have met each of the L2Y and the visitor has won each. BU returns 7 starters from a defense that held UTSA to a season low 255 yards last year. Both enter off wins over FCS foes, but BU has a bye on deck and this is UTSA's road opener. BU was able to rest their starters early LW, whereas UTSA only led Incarnate Word 21-7 at the half. BU is 1-5 ATS vs non-conference foes in the regular season, while UTSA is 12-4 ATS in non-conference road games. We feel UTSA will keep this in-state rivalry game closer than expected as the Roadrunners fare well away from the Alamodome.

ALABAMA by 49 over New Mexico St - Alabama is 24-0 vs FBS non-P5 foes with an avg win of 43-7 since 2008. Bama easily won yet another Neutral site opener last week, beating Duke 42-3 (-32). NMSU is a more experienced team this year with 12 starters back but it didn't help them last week at Wash St in their 59-7 loss (+32). Bama has their SEC opener on deck at S Carolina and you have to expect QB Tagovailoa will be out before the 4Q so a backdoor cover could come into play. Bama was 7-4-1 ATS as a 20+ fav LY but the 4 years prior they were 8-11-2 in that role so be wary.

UCLA by 8 over San Diego St - UCLA holds a 21-0-1 all-time SU series record. The Bruins are off a 24-14 loss at Cincy last Thurs (held to 218 ttl yds) while SDSU struggled against FCS Weber St, winning just 6-0 (238-154). SDSU's bread & butter on OFF is their run game, as RB Juwan Washington nearly topped 1,000 yds (999, 5.0, 10 td) in just 9 gms LY and he is back TY. While UCLA returns all 3 DL starters, they all'd 199 rush ypg (4.9) in '18 and are without 3 key LB due to injury/susp. UCLA is 7-1 SU in home openers, but are just 1-7 ATS. SDSU has 4 SU wins over P12 foes s/16, and are 6-2 ATS as an underdog but are just 2-5 ATS in their L7 road openers. The Aztecs last 11 reg ssn games have been decided by 9 pts or less, so this could go down to the wire.

FLORIDA ST by 16 over ULM - FSU is 2-0 vs ULM incl a 42-10 win in '17 (-26). Extremely disappointing start for FSU in year 2 under HC Taggart. The 'Noles revamped offense under new OC Briles looked potent in early and FSU led Boise St 31-13 (-6) in the 2Q. The 'Noles put up just 68 2W yards and a comedy of errors led to a 5 point loss. ULM enters off a win over Grambling. The WarHawks have 15 starters back and are #3 in experience. They have a bye on deck and catch Florida St in a Boise St/Virginia sandwich. The 'Noles followed up a poor opener LY by nearly losing to Samford. The situation clearly favors ULM so we will call for a closer than expected game.

Wyoming by 3 over TEXAS ST - 4th mtg, and the road team is 0-3 SU. Both teams are off games vs SEC foes as TXSt lost 41-7 at Tex A&M while WY stunned Mizou 37-31 at home. The Cowboys OFF strength is their run gm & over the final 5 gms of '18 WY avgd 285 rush ypg & gashed the Mizou DEF for 297 rush yds. TXSt returns 10 s'trs on DEF, and will focus on stopping the run, and force WY to throw the ball (WY #125 pass OFF in '18). TXSt has 9 s'trs back on OFF and new HC Spavital is an offensive coach, but WY's DEF held foes to 331 ypg LY and returns 6 starters. WY was 2-0 as a AF last year while TXSt was just 1-3 as a HD. TXSt has the edge in exp (#2 vs #77), and gets WY off a huge win so the Cowboys could be in for a letdown, which is why we are calling for WY to win by only a FG.

SMU by 2 over North Texas - This is the 39th 'Safeway Bowl' as these campuses are only 41 miles apart. In LY's season opener in Denton, NTX had a 27-1 FD edge and led 36-0 into the 4Q! While SMU has won 8 of their L13 home openers, 6 were over FCS foes. The Mean Green snapped an 8Y road opener losing streak LY at Arkansas. SMU trailed 23-16, 3Q LW at Ark St before rallying to win 37-30 (+2) as TX trans QB Buechele threw for 360 (61%). NTX led FCS Abilene Christian 38-7 late 2Q & let off the gas. SMU is 13-20 as home chalk. We'll call for the more rested Mean Green to stay within a fg.

TENNESSEE by 7 over Byu - Expectations in Knoxville went up in flames last week just like the boat that caught fire on the Tennessee River prior to the game. Tennessee brought back 16 starters from a 5-7 yet lost to a Georgia ST team that 14 starters back from LY's 2-10 squad. UT did hold a 404-352 yd edge but were -2 TO's. BYU's only td last week vs Utah came in garbage time of their 30-12 (+6). The Cougars were only outgained by 68 yds but were -3 TO's. BYU is 9-2 as an AD under HC Sitake but the Vols were clearly looking ahead last week and will be hungry to prove that last week was a fluke.

Ucf by 7 over FAU - These in-state rivals are meeting for the 3rd time with UCF winning each, including 56-36 (-13) LY. The Knights have lost 16 of 23 road openers, but have won B2B. UCF is on a 4-0 SU run vs in-state FBS foes and enters off a 62-0 blowout over FAMU last Thursday where the starters got plenty of rest and 3rd stringers got plenty of reps. The Knights have scored 30+ pts in 27 straight games (longest FBS streak s/36). FAU trailed 28-0, 1Q at Ohio St LW, but showed no quit and 'only' lost 45-21 (+27). The Owls had -14 yds at the half, but finished with 228. If FAU is the team we think they are, they should keep this game closer than expected.

FIU by 7 over Wku - Two teams that couldn't have gotten off to worse starts to their season. FIU QB Morgan struggled last week at Tulane (19-34-208-1-1) and the Panthers were outgained 545-267. Power Sweep subscribers were given a free Marquee winner (2-0 in College Bonuses!) with FIU/Tulane going UNDER the total in FIU's 42-14 loss (+2). The Tyson Helton era got off to a rocky start last week with WKU losing to FCS Central Arkansas 35-28 (-9). The Hilltoppers did get a solid performance from RB Walker (152 yds, 8.0). FBS teams that are off losses to FCS teams typically play well the following week (5-2 ATS LY). WKU was also in this spot last year, off an FCS loss they easily covered at Louisville, only losing 20-17 (+23). WKU is 15-8-2 as an AD while HC Davis is just 2-6 as a HF so we will go with the dog here to keep this closer than expected.

KANSAS by 11 over Coastal Carolina - 1st meeting. This is the road opener for CC and they are still searching for their 1st SU win in that role since joining the FBS in '17. KU led FCS Indiana St 16-3, 4Q LW, then survived a late scare to win 24-17. RB Williams will return after serving a 1 gm susp. CC ply'd well in defeat LW, outgaining Eastern Michigan 378-315. QB Payton threw for 304 (67%), but the Jayhawks had 2 int's LW including a 57 yd IR td. KU has a trip to BC on deck. CC is on a 1-7-1 ATS run. Tough game to pick here, but we'll side with KU by DD's.

LOUISIANA by 12 over Liberty - First mtg. LA is 10-1 SU in their L11 true home openers, but 8 were vs FCS foes. Last week LU was shut out by 'Cuse 24-0 (held to 234 ttl yds), while LA lost 38-28 vs Miss St in the Superdome, but gained 431 ttl yds. Last year LU all'd 222 ypg & 5.2 ypc and LA ran for 219 ypg (5.5) LY. LA's trio of dynamic RB's of Ragas, Calias, and Mitchell all return this ssn & LA ran for 164 yds vs an SEC defense last week. The Flames return OFF playmakers in QB Calvert and WR Gandy-Golden and will test the LA secondary. LU was just 1-5 LY on the road SU (2-4 ATS), while the Cajuns were 5-1 SU at home last ssn (3-2-1 ATS). Both teams have exp (LU #5, LA #15) and LA is at home, has the better offense & we trust their DEF more, which is why we like the Cajuns to win by nearly 2 TD's.

MICHIGAN ST by 17 over Western Michigan - The last 3 meetings between these in-state rivals have been decided by 13 ppg with the last matchup taking place in '17. MST enters with an extra day of prep/rest following their win over Tulsa last Friday where they set a program record allowing -73 rush yds! Sparty has a revenge game vs AZST on deck. WM QB Wassink threw for 368 (80%, 5-0) in their easy win over FCS Monmouth LW. Not only does Sparty have a dominant rush D, but their pass D only all'd 153 yds LW as well. MST is 0-5 as DD chalk, 0-6 as home chalk & 4-12 as non-conference chalk of 28 pts or less, while WM is 14-7 as an AD. We like Sparty, but agree with the Vegas line.

AU has won 13 straight home openers, while TU has lost 10 of their L/14 road openers, including 5 straight. The Green Wave enter with 2 extra days of prep/rest following their dominant 42-14 (-3) win vs FIU last Thursday (congrats PS subs on free marquee win on the UNDER!) and has FCS Missouri St on deck. TU runs a spread option offense, which hasn't been seen by AU under HC Malzahn. The Green Wave used a 4-headed monster rush attack LW to account for 350 (7.1) rush yds. AU never led the entire game LW until :09 were left in their 27-21 (-4) win over Oregon. Their D led by a dominant DL did allow just 90 (2.7) rush. TU is 2-5 as an AD and we'll side with Auburn by nearly 3 TD's.

OLE MISS by 3 over Arkansas - Arkansas has won 4 straight in this series and there were 4 straight outright upsets until LY when the Hogs led 33-24 before allowing the GW TD with just :42 left. Ole Miss held a 639-405 yd edge. Mississippi brought back just 3 starters on offense, losing their QB, top 3 WR's, and 3 Oline. The lack of experience showed as they put up just 173 yards and QB Corral threw for 93 yards last week. The defense returned 10 starters and held Memphis to 364 yds. Ark only won 20-13 over an FCS Portland St team that went 4-7 LY. Ole Miss is just 4-9 ATS at home and Arkansas will be out for revenge after letting LY's game slip away. This series is always close (L/4 meetings decided by 10 points) so we have the Rebels by a fg.

OREGON by 31 over Nevada - Oregon is 6-1 SU all-time against Nev with their last mtg coming back in 2011 (69-20 UO win). The Ducks are off a last-second loss (27-21, gave up GW TD w/ 9 sec left) against Auburn, where they led 21-6 late 3Q. Nev had an impressive comeback win vs Purdue, as they trailed 31-14 3Q but came back & made a GW 56 yd FG as time expired and could be in for a letdown. UO has one of the top QB's in the nation, while Nev's RS frosh QB Carson Strong was 30/51 for 295 & 3 TD's LW, but here is making his first road start. UO has not lost a home opener SU since 2004 (14 straight), and have scored over 40 pts in 13 of those gms. Nev is 6-11 ATS the L5Y as an AD, while the Ducks are just 3-7 ATS as a 20+ favorite in that same span. However, the Ducks has a HUGE exp edge (#1 vs #112) and we expect UO to come out motivated after their tough loss last week and win here by over 4 TD's.

PENN ST by 27 over Buffalo - PSU has won 6 straight games over MAC members by 32 ppg. UB enters with a couple of extra days of rest/prep following their 38-10 win over FCS Robert Morris. Matt Myers was the 1st frosh QB to start for the Bulls in 28Y, but attempted just 10 passes. PSU is essentially off a bye following their 79-7 win over FCS Idaho as the starters got plenty of rest and the bkps got plenty of reps. The Nittany Lions have rival Pitt on deck. UB is 4-1 as an AD & is on a 17-6 ATS run, while PSU is on a 24-11-1 ATS run & is 14-8-1 as home chalk. We'll call this game right at the line.

KENTUCKY by 10 over Eastern Michigan - Only prior meeting was in '17. EM led 7-0 & it was 14-14 at half but KY went ahead 24-14 before EM scored with 2:34 left. The 'Cats looked like they were going to have another rough opener vs a Group-of-5 foe when they trailed Toledo 14-7 2Q but the Rockets QB was injured in the 3Q and Kentucky led 38-17 before a late Toledo td. EM enters off a 30-23 (-6) win at Coastal Carolina. QB Glass completed 20-22-188-3-0. Now he faces a rebuilt 'Cats secondary that lost all 4 starters from LY. EM has been money as an underdog, hitting at a 19-3-1 clip the last 3 years incl 4-1-1 as a HD. Kentucky is just 1-9 as a HF.

TEXAS TECH by 38 over Utep - In-state rivals last met in '15. UTEP has lost 35 straight games vs current P5 members by 30 ppg! This is the Miners road opener and they have a bye on deck. The Miners trailed FCS Houston Baptist (2 SU wins L2Y) into the 4Q LW. TT enters off a dominant 45-10 win over Montana ST, allowing just 8 FD's. UTEP allowed 300 (73%, 2-0) pass yds and TT QB Bowman threw for 436 (73%) LW. TT has a trip to Arizona on deck but HC Wells was 11-3 as 20+ pt chalk at Utah ST incl 5-1 last year so we don't expect the Red Raiders to take their foot off the gas.

Stanford by 1 over USC - This is the 6th straight year meeting in their P12 opener. Stanford has won 4 of the L/6 at the Coliseum, but did lose 42-24 (+6) LTH ('17). USC was held to their fewest points s/97 in LY's 17-3 (+5) loss. Stanford is on a 11-5 ATS series run. Both programs suffered the loss of their starting QB's LW (USC Daniels OFY). The Cardinal were still able to beat NW 17-7 despite bkp QB Mills completing 50% as we cashed our top weekly LPS 4★ total on the UNDER. USC bkp QB Slovis hit 6-8-57-0-1 LW. Stanford is 2-5 ATS in their road opener, but is 26-11 ATS in P12 road games. USC is 3-8 ATS at home. There's no line at press time.

WASHINGTON by 13 over California - UW is on a 9-4 ATS series run. This is the P12 opener for each. UW is in revenge mode after falling 12-10 (-11') LY despite not allowing an offensive td. Both enter off wins over FCS foes as UW finished with a 570-274 yd edge and Cal had a 471-266 yd edge. Cal has won 9 of their L/12 road openers, including 5 straight. Cal is 5-0 as an AD, while UW is 1-4 as home chalk & 1-7 as P12 chalk. Tough to lean with either side and we'll call for Cal to keep this game slightly closer than expected.

Minnesota by 4 over FRESNO ST - In LY's 1st ever meeting MN scored the GW TD w/3:28 left then got an int in the EZ to preserve the win. The Gophers have won 12 of their L/17 road openers and last travelled this far West in '17, beating Oregon ST by 34 points. FSt has won 13 of their L/15 home openers, but 10 were vs FCS foes. MN struggled in their opener last Thursday, trailing FCS South Dakota ST in the 4Q, but benefitted from a fumble leading to the GW 34 yd TD drive w/5:39 left. The Gophers avg just 3.1 ppc, were outg'd 367-308, and also got an IR TD. The Bulldogs have a bye on deck and trailed USC LW 31-13 into the 4Q before cutting it to 8. FSt is 9-13 ATS vs non-conference foes. MN is on an 8-5 ATS run & HC Fleck is 6-3 as away chalk.

HAWAII by 6 over Oregon St - OSU holds a 7-3 lead in this series, with the last mtg here coming back in '14 (OSU won 38-30). OSU got into a slugfest with Okla ST last week & lost 52-36 while all g 555 ttl yds. UH already beat a Pac-12 foe at home 2 weeks ago & come into this game off a bye. UH's QB McDonald threw for 378 & 4 TD's in that gm, but also threw 4 int's and will likely be on a short leash here. OSU's pass D all'd Okla ST to go 19/24 for 203 yds and will be tasked with trying to stop UH's Run 'n Shoot pass attack that saw WR Cedric Byrd catch 14 passes for 224 yds & 4 TD vs Ariz. OSU is 0-5 ATS in road openers dating back to '14, but UH is just 3-9 as a HF under HC Rolovich. Neither side has a strong DEF, so expect a lot of points here. We were impressed with what UH did in their opener & think they pick up another close win here.

4★ Pittsburgh over NEW ENGLAND - SNF - The Steelers and Patriots have become quite the rivalry since the 2001 ssn where Tom Brady went into PIT for the AFC Championship and came out victorious. Since that matchup, PIT and NE have met 13 other times (incl playoffs) with the Patriots holding a 9-4 SU (8-4-1 ATS) advantage. Many of the top offensive targets for both sides (Rob Gronkowski, Le'Veon Bell & Antonio Brown) have moved on but these 2 are still expected to be in the mix for the AFC Title. While NE is 11-2 ATS as a HF, they did suffer the crucial loss of their starting center less than 2 wks ago. PIT has covered each of their past 6 as an AD incl 5 outright upsets and will look to make a statement here as nearly a TD underdog!

FORECAST: Pittsburgh by 1

3★ MINNESOTA over Atlanta - While the Falcons and Vikings entered LY with playoff aspirations, injuries and inconsistency saw them combine for just a 15-16-1 overall mark. ATL has won 3 of their past 4 road openers (2-2 ATS) but have also struggled against NDIV foes recently with just a 2-9 ATS run. The Vikings meanwhile have been an ATS darling with 4 consec home opening spread victories (5 pt avg cover). With MIN also 19-5-1 ATS as a HF and the Falcons covering just 1 of their 7 as an AD, the smart money is with the hometown Vikings in this one.

FORECAST: MINNESOTA by 10

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Baltimore over MIAMI - While the Dolphins actually finished the '18 campaign with a serviceable 7-9 record, a further look into their year saw plenty of smoke and mirrors as MIA was outgained in all but 2 of their matchups (-101 ypg on the ssn, 3rd worst in NFL!). The Ravens changed up their scheme at the midway point of LY with Lamar Jackson taking over for Joe Flacco and leading BAL to wins 6 of their L7 to capture the AFC North crown. While opposing defenses now have some game film to study on the mobile Jackson and the Ravens are just 3-7 ATS as a NDIV AF, backing this rebuilding Dolphins squad appears to be too risky.

FORECAST: Baltimore by 13

OTHER PLAYS

Green Bay at CHICAGO - Thursday - The Packers head to CHI having dropped 5 of their past 6 as a DIV AD incl a 24-17 defeat (+5) late LY in Soldier Field (first loss in CHI s'10, 29-20 avg win prior to '18). The Bears meanwhile are on a perfect 7-0 ATS run while covering 9 of their past 12 contests overall. Although CHI has also covered 7 in a row in NFC North play, new GB HC Matt LaFleur appears to have Rodgers and company already bought in to the new system (Packers have won 13 of the past 17 in the series SU). **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

PHILADELPHIA by 13 over Washington - The Redskins head into Philly having dropped 4 consec matchups in this series incl a 24-0 home defeat to end the '18 campaign (PHI 16 pt avg victory L2Y). The Eagles on the other hand are fresh off of B2B playoff appearances and appear to be one of the favorites in the NFC once again. Although the line is closing in on double digits in the season opening matchup, keep in mind that WAS is breaking in a new QB while also covering just 3 of their past 13 DIV matchups.

NY JETS by 1 over Buffalo - There's plenty of new faces roaming the sidelines for the Jets in '19 highlighted by Le'Veon Bell and CJ Mosley. The Bills meanwhile head to MetLife Stadium with a solid 6-1-2 ATS mark as a DIV AD incl a 41-10 blowout (+7) here a year ago where they finished with massive FD (23-12) and yard (451-199) edges. With the Jets breaking in a new HC and having failed to cover 6 of their past 7 matchups inside of the AFC East, we'll go ahead and take the points here as BUF has actually pulled out a pair of outright upsets in road openers over the past 5 years!

San Francisco by 3 over TAMPA BAY - The 49ers head to Tampa for the 1st of 2 trips to the EST to begin the '19 campaign (at CIN on deck). The Bucs meanwhile started off a perfect 2-0 a year ago (upsets of NO & PHI) before going on to drop 11 of their past 14 to close out '18. LY the Bucs got a 27-9 win over a banged up 49ers squad with a 412-342 yd edge. With TB breaking in a new system under Bruce Arians and going just 4-13 ATS as a HF (Thur night matchup vs CAR on deck), we'll back a now healthy Jimmy Garoppolo-led SF squad that's covered 6 of their past 8 season openers.

Kansas City by 3 over JACKSONVILLE - The Chiefs head into the '19 season as one of the favorites to claim the Lombardi Trophy following LY's offensive explosion. JAX on the other hand went from a trip to the AFC Championship in '17 to a horrid 5-11 finish LY with their 15.3 ppg the 2nd worst in the NFL. While the Chiefs are on a 5-1 ATS run in recent road openers, it appeared that the sportsbooks caught up to them late in '18 as they failed to cover 4 of their past 5 regular ssn meetings. With the Jaguars covering all 3 matchups as a home dog a year ago incl SU upsets of NE & IND (both were in '18 playoffs), we'll call for the home squad to stay within the line.

CLEVELAND by 3 over Tennessee - Following a 9-7 performance a year ago and a narrow miss in making the AFC playoffs, the Titans head to CLE having covered 5 of their past 6 road openers. The Browns enter '19 as the media darling of the league following an outstanding end to LY and the acquisitions brought in during the offseason. Although CLE has covered 4 of their past 5 home openers overall, they haven't earned a SU win in Wk 1 since way back in 2004! While we'll go ahead and call for that streak to end here against the Titans, their recent history has us only laying a FG in their favor.

LA Rams by 6 over CAROLINA - The Rams have strung together some outstanding performances over the past 2 years incl a trip to LY's SB. They now head into the heat and humidity of Charlotte against a Panthers squad that was covered 5 straight as a NDIV HD. While CAR is on just a 2-6 ATS overall run, keep in mind that LA has covered just 3 of their past 12 meeting against NDIV foes. Although the Panthers are a solid 6-2 ATS in home openers and possess one of the top LB units in the league, questions regarding QB Newton's health entering Wk 1 has us leaning with the defending NFC Champs.

Detroit by 6 over ARIZONA - While the Lions have covered 3 consec road openers (all as dogs) heading into 2019, they'll be the favorite this time around as they take on a Cardinals squad that's breaking in a new HC and QB following LY's DEAD LAST finish in nearly every offensive category. In LY's ssn opener the Lions suffered an embarrassing home performance against the Jets on MNF (31 pt loss as 7 pt chalk). With 2nd yr HC Matt Patricia going 6-2 ATS on the road in his inaugural campaign with the Lions, we expect them to continue that solid trend as a visitor in the desert against the rebuilding Cardinals.

SEATTLE by 13 over Cincinnati - The Seahawks finished LY on an 8-3-1 ATS run while earning a playoff berth in the process. The Bengals meanwhile have gone through a big transition this offssn following the departure of 16-yr HC Marvin Lewis. While CIN has gone 7-2 ATS as an AD in recent years, they have also failed to cover 8 of their past 12 overall against the NFC. With a pumped up crowd expected to be on hand in one of the NFL's best venues, the Seahawks get the DD lean in this one as they've posted a 7-2-2 ATS mark against NDIV foes.

LA CHARGERS by 10 over Indianapolis - To say that the Colts are a slow starter is a bit of an understatement as over the past 11 season openers, IND has gone just 1-10 ATS (2-9 SU) in that span (16 pt avg defeat in the 9 losses!). The Chargers on the other hand have had quite a bit of success in Wk 1 with an impressive 5-1-1 ATS mark. With both squads earning WC spots a year ago and once again having playoff aspirations for '19 despite IND losing top signal-caller Luck to a premature retirement (bkp Brissett took all the #1 snaps during camp), we'll go ahead and side with the trends in this matchup as the Chargers finished LY covering 6 of their final 8.

DALLAS by 10 over NY Giants - This marks the 5th consec year that the Cowboys open their home sked against the Giants with DAL holding a 3-1 SU (2-1-1 ATS) during that span incl a 20-13 (-3) victory a year ago. The Giants made plenty of controversial changes this offssn in what could very well be Eli Manning's LY under center in NY. The Cowboys meanwhile remain a playoff favorite in '19 after claiming the NFC East a year ago. With the Giants having gone just 1-6-1 ATS overall in Wk 1 and DAL covering 10 of their past 12 in DIV play, we'll go ahead and give them the DD lead in this one despite RB Elliott missing this matchup.

Houston at NEW ORLEANS - MNF - Despite a handful of playoff appearances over the past 7 years, ssn opening matchups have not gone too well in favor of the Saints as they've won and covered just 1 contest during that span. The Texans head into the Superdome on a 7-2-1 ATS run while also covering 6 of their past 8 as a NDIV AD. HOU has however dropped 4 of their past 5 in non-conf play which could make for a long night in the "Big Easy". Denver at OAKLAND - MNF - The Broncos (4-1-2 ATS in Wk 1) head to the Bay Area seeking revenge after LY's MNF defeat in Wk 16 where the Raiders won 27-14 despite a 300-273 yd disadvantage. DEN will have a new QB under center once again in Joe Flacco while OAK also boosted their offense with a trade for All-Pro Antonio Brown. While DEN is just 5-14-1 ATS vs AFC West foes, the Raiders' 4-11 ATS mark as a DIV HF has us waiting until game day to make a decision in this one.
