4★ Purdue (+) over INDIANA - LY the Hoosiers were 7 pt chalk and led 28-10 3Q but needed OT to win 44-41. HC Tom Allen has done a marvelous job with the Hoosiers this year and LW, playing without QB Penix (OFY) Indiana pulled out a 14-6 outright upset over Wisc as 13 pt dogs. QB Tuttle only threw for 122 yds and Indiana finished with just 217 tl yds. The Boilermakers trailed 17-0 1Q vs Neb thanks to a blocked punt and a long PR last week. Pur got within a touchdown in the 4Q but ultimately lost 37-27 (-2). Their DEF does hold foes 47 ypg below their avg. Pur is also ply'g with their bkp QB, Jack Plummer, but he's got an 8-2 ratio and threw for 334 last week. The Boilermakers are 2-4 but only -9 ypg while Indiana is 6-1 but -4 ypg. Indiana is 10-1 as a HF but Purdue is 7-1 as an AD. Pur is off a deceiving loss while Indiana is off a deceiving win so we will call for Purdue to keep it VERY close and the last 4 mtgs have been decided by 7 or less. **FORECAST: INDIANA by 3**

3★ Appalachian St over GEORGIA SOUTHERN - These two former Southern Conf rivals have met every ssn since '93. While App St is not in the SBC title gm this year, they will be out for revenge after losing to GStHrn the past 2 snns as a ranked team. App St's rush attack is avg'g 251 yds (5.4) this ssn behind a strong trio of RB's led by Camerun Peoples (738, 5.8) but face a GStHrn run D that is all'g just 79 ypg (3.0) to SBC foes. GStHrn is rushing for 268 ypg (5.4) despite not having their top 2 RB's, but QB Werts leads with 649 (5.0) & bkp RB Wright (536, 6.9) has filled in nicely. GStHrn faces an App run D giving up 129 rush ypg (3.8) vs SBC foes. App St QB Thomas (1867, 65%, 17-10) could be able to take adv of GStHrn's #75 ranked pass D that all'd GSt to throw for 372 yds 2 wks ago. Against 6 common SBC foes App is +118 ypg & +11 ppg while GStHrn is just +8 ypg & -1 ppg. App St is 10-2-1 ATS vs FBS foes when off a SU loss and with no title game to look forward to GStHrn gets their full attention & we think App gets their revenge to close the regular ssn.

FORECAST: APPALACHIAN ST by 17

3★ Fresno St over NEW MEXICO - FSt is 5-0 SU/ATS over NMex as MW foes & Fresno has won those gms by an avg score of 46-18 and cover by an avg of 14 pts. FSt is avg'g 515 yds & 35 pts over their L/4 gms led by QB Haener (1671, 66%, 11-4) who threw for 485 last wk & RB Rivers (508, 5.1, 7 td) and face a NMex DEF that is giving up 75 ypg more than their foes avg. NMex's OFF has only put up 330 ypg the L/4 gms but the FSt DEF has all'd foes to gain 88 ypg above their ssn avg. FSt is already 2-0 ATS TY as an AF and NMex is 3-6 ATS the L3Y as a HD vs MW foes. NMex is 1-5 SU & is off a big win vs WY but could be eager to just get back home after relocating to Vegas over a month ago to be able to play this ssn while Fresno St is off a loss but have been more impressive this ssn & have owned this series as MW foes. **FORECAST: Fresno St by 21**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Wisconsin over IOWA - UW is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS vs Iowa and they've are 5-0 SU/4-1 ATS in Iowa City. LY UW only won 24-22 (-8) but the Badgers lead 21-6 4Q and finished w/a 473-295 yd edge. The Badgers enter off a surprising home loss vs Indiana who was w/o their starting QB. UW finished with 342-217 yd & 19-15 FD edges but lost 14-6 (-13). Since losing their first 2 games, Iowa has won 5 straight (4-1 ATS run) including last week's 35-21 (-13) win at Illinois. Iowa trailed 14-0 2Q then scored 35 straight before IL added a td in garbage time. The Hawkeyes are +47 ypg and their defense holds foes 54 ypg below their avg. UW is only 2-2 on the season but the Badgers are +172 ypg and they hold foes 157 ypg below their avg. The Badgers are 15-5 as an AF and Iowa has failed to cover their last 2 as home dogs. We can't see the Badgers dropping a 3rd straight game and their defense, which only allows 72 (2.9) rush ypg will limit the Iowa run game which puts pressure on QB Petras who has 5 int's this ssn so we'll take the Badgers by a td. **FORECAST: Wisconsin by 3**

2★ Utah over COLORADO - As Pac-12 foes Utah is 7-2 SU and have covered the L/4 gms after Colo covered the F/5. Colo comes in 4-0 SU/ATS while Utah got their 1st win of the ssn last week vs Oreg St (30-24, 403-335). Utah's run gm has been strong their last 2 gms (222 ypg, 5.2 ypc) and do face a Colorado run D that is all'd 268 yds (6.2) to Arizona last week. Despite having a 1st year HC Colorado has suprised us this season as Senior QB Noyer (742, 62%, 4-4) is leading the way along with RB Broussard (733, 6.4). They face a solid Utah DEF giving up 351 ypg and are holding their foes to 97 ypg under their season avg. Colorado needs this win to stay in the hunt for the Pac-12 title game while Utah needs a win to finish the ssn out strong. We think behind their strong run game & defense the Utes will go into Boulder and spoil the Buffs undefeated ssn. **FORECAST: Utah by 5**

Fau at SOUTHERN MISS - FAU is 2-0 SU/ATS and won LY 34-17 (-9). The Owls only led 24-17 4Q and finished with a 300-258 yd edge. SM last played on 11/21. They've lost their L/2 by a fg each vs UTSA & at WKU. FAU enters off a 20-3 (+2) loss at Georgia Southern. The Owls didn't punt once in their last 7 possessions but only scored 3 points (4 TO's, 2 SOD's). Both offenses have struggled this year but FAU does have a big edge on defense, holding foes 38 ypg below their avg. SM allows 48 ypg more than their foes avg. The Golden Eagles do have 3 close losses. FAU only allows 12 ppg and SM only avg 21 ppg in CUSA play. SM is 1-4 ATS at home this year but they've only been a dog in 1 of those and covered vs UTSA.

Pittsburgh at GEORGIA TECH - Pitt is 4-1 SU in this series and has won & covered the last 2. GT enters off a 23-13 (+6) loss at NCSt. The Jackets finished w/a 412-397 yd edge and had 0 TO's but were SOD 3 times. Pitt enters fresh off a scheduled by. The Panthers were without several OLine starters vs Clemson 2 weeks ago and were crushed 52-17. Pitt is +28 ypg on the season while GT is -59 ypg. Against 7 common foes, Pitt is 3-4 SU/1-5-1 ATS, -6 ppg & -18 ypg. GT is 2-5 SU/3-4 ATS, -16 ppg & -69 ypg. QB Sims had a 3-8 ratio in his first ratio in his first 3 games but has an 8-3 ratio in his last 6. GT does have 2 outright upsets at home this year while Pitt is 5-3 as away chalk. Arizona St by 11 over ARIZONA - Ariz leads the "Duel in the Desert" 49-43-1 SU. Before LY's game (ASU -13' on road, won 24-14) the home tm had covered 6 in a row. ASU played just their 2nd game of the ssn last wk & lost vs UCLA despite having the yds edge (442-363, -2 TO's) while Ariz is 0-4 SU (1-3 ATS) on the ssn and are avg'g just 374 yds and 20 pts on offense. Ariz fresh QB Plummer is the starter after Gunnell inj'd his shoulder vs UCLA. While ASU gave up 556 yds to USC their DEF did a solid job last week (held UCLA to 85 yds below ssn avg). The ASU offense has put up 417 ypg and faces an Ariz DEF that is all'g 470 ypg & are giving up 49 ypg more than their foes avg. ASU has also ran for 212 ypg (5.8) and face a Wildcats run D that is all'g 274 ypg (6.1) this ssn. Ariz comes in on a 3-10 ATS slide vs Pac 12 foes the L2Y, and while ASU is just 4-7 ATS the L2Y vs Pac 12 foes they seem to be playing better ball while this is a lost ssn for Ariz.

NORTH TEXAS by 3 over Utep - NT is 3-0 SU/2-1 ATS in this series and won LY 52-26 (-23'). The home team is 4-0 SU/ATS. The Mean Green ply'd a LA Tech squad that hadn't ply'd since 10/31 due to Covid but still lost 42-31 despite a 386-341 yd edge. UTEP last played on 11/14 and they've lost their last 3 games but they did have the yards edge in 2 of those losses. UTEP hasn't ply'd a home game since 9/19 and this gm has been moved to Denton. The Miners are -39 ypg and their offense avg 104 ypg less than their foes allow. NT is +7 ypg but their offense avg 96 ypg more than their foes

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allow on avg. UTEP gave up 288 rush yds in their last game and NT avg 235 (5.5). The Mean Green is 2-6 as an AF but UTEP is 2-7 as a HD and we give NT a field goal edge because of their offense.

MARSHALL by 17 over Charlotte - MU is out for revenge after losing LY 24-13 (-7). The Herd led 10-7 at half but the 49ers finished w/a 422-230 yd edge and got bowl elig for the first time ever. Last week we went against undefeated Marshall as our Underdog POW. Marshall was 22 pt chalk but put up just 245 yds and was shutout 20-0! QB Wells entered last week with 4 int's but threw 5 vs Rice including a pick 6.UC ply'd on Sunday and lost at home vs WKU 37-19 (+2). The Herd are +171 ypg and are holding foes 74 ypg below their avg. UC allows 213 rush ypg (5.9) and faces RB Knox who has topped 100 rush in 5 of 8 gms. MU is only 7-16 as HF and was 0-4 ATS off a SU loss last year so we give a slight lean to the 49ers.

↑ Nevada by 3 over San Jose St - Since 2002 Nev is 15-2 SU/12-5 ATS against SJSt. Nev is off a 36-27 win vs Fresno (3★ LP winner on Nev!) while SJSt is off a win at Hawaii. This gm was supposed to be in San Jose but SJSt is unable to play home gms (covid restrictions) so this game will be played in Las Vegas. Nev's OFF led by QB Strong (2327, 70%, 21-4) and WR Doubs (44 rec, 885 yds, 9 td) has been held to 390 ypg the L/4 gms (512 ypg F/3 gms). They face a SJSt DEF that is holding foes to 347 ypg/17 ppg. SJSt's OFF is led by their strong pass game (QB Starker 1147, 66%, 11-3) and Nev gave up 485 pass yds last wk to Fresno. Against 4 common MW foes SJSt is +91 ypg/+14 ppg while Nev is +71 ypg but just +7 ppg. SJSt needs a win to clinch a spot in the MW title gm while Nev needs a win & a Boise win to make the title gm. We think this gm comes down to the wire & will side with the Pack (8-3 ATS L3Y as a MW dog) to win by a FG.

SATURDAY DECEMBER 12TH

OHIO ST by 34 over Michigan - OSU is 8-0 SU in 'The Game' and they've won the last 2 by 29 & 23. The Buckeyes have put up 56 & 62 points and 567 and 577 yds the last 2 years. Mich had their game postponed last week so hopefully this gets played. We won our Early Bird Selection (Free on Monday's Comp Tape, Button #9, 1-347-677-1700) on OSU in their 52-12 (-21) win over Mich St. The Buckeyes were w/o several starters including 3 on the OLine due to Covid but still put up 521 yds. The Buckeyes ran for 322 yds LW and Mich allowed over 250+ rush yds in 2 of their L/3. Mich is allowing 72 ypg more than their foes avg and OSU is putting up 175 ypg more than their foes allow. The Buckeyes defense isn't on par with LY's unit, allowing more than 100 ypg more than the '19 unit. This is the largest line in series history but considering HC Day supposedly told his team they'd 'hang 100' on Michigan we don't mind laying big points. This game has gone 'Over' the Total in 7 straight years so this will certainly be in the mix for our Totals Game of the Year!

PENN ST by 17 over Michigan St - MSU is 5-2 SU/ATS in this series but they've split the L/4 mtgs and PSU did win Rutgers (-5) last year. PSU has won 2 straight after beating Rutgers 23-7 (-11'). The Nittany Lions held Rutgers to a ssn low 205 yds and finished +176 yds. MSU is off a 52-12 (+21) loss against a shorthanded OSU team that was missing 3 starting Oline due to Covid. MSU is 2-4 while PSU is 2-5 but Sparty is -76 ypg on the season while the Nittany Lions are +85 ypg. MSU is only putting up 320 ypg and 62 ypg less than their foes allow on avg. PSU is all'g 327 ypg and 78 ypg less than their foes avg. They've held 3 of their opponents to their ssn low yards. Since their 0-5 start HC Franklin wants to build momentum for next year and they could finish with a 4 game B10 win streak. MSU was blown out by 42 in their last road game at Iowa. Penn St has momentum and the edge on offense and defense so we will call for the Nittany Lions to win by more than 2 td's and HC Franklin is 28-10-1 ATS the last 4 years when coming off a SU win.

MARYLAND by 6 over Rutgers - MD has won the last 2 mtgs by a combined score of 82-14. The Terps have had 3 of their last 4 games cancelled including LW vs Michigan. Rutgers was held to ssn lows 205 yds and 7 points in a 16 pt loss at home vs PSU (+11) last week. The Scarlet Knights have yet to hold the yds edge this ssn and are -78 ypg. MD is -46 ypg but they've yet to be favored in a game. Rutgers is -78 ypg and their offense avg 51 ypg less than their foes allow but MD's defense allows 443 ypg and 81 ypg more than their foes avg. The Terps do own upset wins over Minn & PSU. QB Tagovialoa has a 7-7 ratio but allows 66% completions and 3 of their 7 foes have topped 300 pass yds. Locksley is 2-0 as home chalk at MD but Schiano is 3-0 as an away dog with 2 outright upsets this year and we think Rutgers stays within a touchdown.

BALL ST by 7 over Western Michigan - This game is for MAC West Title. Broncos are 5-1 SU & 4-2 ATS vs the Cardinals but have not covered the L/2 & LTH lost 42-41 in OT as a 7 pt AF. LY WM led 21-10 at HT but trailed 24-21 & 31-28 in 4Q before scoring the GW td w/1:05 left (Ball St SOD at own 29). These 2 teams have had reverse seasons. After losing their opener Ball St won their last 4 & after losing the F/3 ATS have covered the L/2. WWM won their first 4 before losing LW & after covering their F/3 have lost L/2 ATS. Against MAC West foes both are 2-2 ATS with Ball St 4-0 SU & WM 3-1. In those gms Ball St is outscoring foes 35-25 with a 479-420 yd edge while WM thanks to a 11 pt loss to EM is avg 41-41 with a 476-448 yd edge. The Cardinals have been impressive so they get the call and Ball St does have the offensive edge (#41-#53) & defensive edge (#94-#119).

Miami, Oh by 27 over BOWLING GREEN - Miami is 3-1 SU & ATS vs BG including 2 straight wins. LY MU only led 10-3 into the 2Q but led 37-3 at HT & cruised to a 44-3 win as a 17 pt HF. LW Miami had their 2nd game cancelled TY due to Covid issues at Kent St. Due to this being Miami's 4th game, they have just 2 common foes TY. Both lost to Buffalo SU with both allowing 42 pts but Miami without their starting QB only scored 10 (7 in 4Q) for their only ATS loss, while BG put up 17 (14 in 4Q) for their only ATS win (+30'). Against Akron, MU won 38-7 with a 416-145 yd edge. BG lost to Akron 31-3 but had a 295-282 yd edge as they were -3 TO & gave a blocked punt td. The RedHawks have the offensive edge (#102-#127) & an even larger defensive edge (#72-#129). Miami is the better team & hoping to end their ssn on a high note while BG may just be trying to end their ssn.

BUFFALO by 24 over Akron - LW UB was on the buses & 2.5 hrs into their drive to play Ohio, when they got the news the game was cancelled & the had to turn around. That same call meant the Bulls clinched the MAC East. Then on Sun they became rnk'd for the first time ever (#24). Bulls are led by RB Patterson who despite ply'g in just 4 gms needs just 80 yds for his 3rd straight 1,000 yd ssn. He is avg 8.6 ypc & has 16 rush td. Akron is all'g 212 ypg rush & 5.6 ypc. Akron is off their only win of the ssn beating winless BG 31-3 thanks to a bkp punt td & +3 TO as they were actually outg'd 295-282. While the winner is all but certain, UB did not cover vs BG as a 30' pt AF and are a 30+ pt HF here. With the MAC Title gm on deck we expect the Bulls to shut it down in the 2H and keep Patterson healthy, meaning that the Zips should be able to get their 3rd cover of the ssn.

EASTERN MICHIGAN by 3 over Northern Illinois - LY the Huskies had their 11 gm win streak over the Eagles snapped as EM had a 24 pt 3Q explosion & won 45-17 as a 5 pt AD. LTH NIU was a dog (+3') for the first time in series since '98 and pulled out a 26-23 win in 3 OT. Huskies are looking for their first win & after taking WM to the wire 2 wks ago, NIU pushed toledo last week as it was 24-24 in 4Q but they allowed UT to score 17 unanswered. The Eagles upset WM 53-42 as a 13' pt AD for their first win of the season. While they have the offensive edge (#99-#113) NIU has the defensive edge (#104-#115). Against MAC West tm's EM is being outscored 39-34 and outgained 523-432. NIU is being outscored 36-22 & outgained 446-347. The Eagles are favored for the first time this ssn & with history of their side we look for the Huskies to keep it close here.

KENT ST by 4 over Ohio - Ohio has won 6 straight vs Kent St but after covering the first 4 have failed to the last 2. LY's game has 7 lead changes & was tied at 17, 24 & 31 in the 4Q. Ohio went up 45-31 before KSU scored a td w/31 left for the backdoor cover as a 7' pt AD (Ohio rec'd outside). Under HC Solich Ohio has avg'd just 16 ppg, with a high of 27 the LTH. Both are 2-0 SU vs common foes (BG & Akron) all as Fav of 20+. Both won & covered vs BG (KS 62-24, -20 & Ohio 52-10, -23). After a close 1H vs Akron (led 35-28) Kent St pulled away in 2H for a 69-35 win as a 26' pt HF. Ohio only led 14-10 mid-3Q before winning 24-10 as a 27' pt HF. Both had Covid issues that forced the cancellation of LW's games so this game & who is playing is up in the air at press time.

TOLEDO by 7 over Central Michigan - Rockets had won 9 straight in the series heading into LY's game. LY thanks to a WM loss 3 days earlier, CM knew they only had to win to make the MAC Championship and they took know chances destroying Toledo 49-7 as a 10' pt HF outgaining UT 552-256. Both are out of the MAC West, both lost SU & ATS to WM & Ball St & both are 3-0 SU & ATS in their other 3 games. Against MAC West foes CM is outscoring them 34-33 but are being out-gained 519-342 but are +5 TO's in those games, while UT is outscoring them 37-30 with a 512-376 yd edge but are even in TO's in those games. Toledo has the edge on both offense (#52-#88) and defense (#92-#106). While the Rockets are playing with revenge they open a DD HF and we look for an opportunistic CM team to be able to keep the game closer than that.

FLORIDA by 17 over Lsu - This was one of LSU's closest games LY in their Nat'l Title ssn. The Tigers only led 35-28 4Q and nearly tied the gm but was intercepted in the EZ by DB Stingley. We went against LSU for a 3★ LPS last week and the Tigers were crushed by avengeful Bama squad 55-17 (+29*). LSU was outgained by 298 yds and allowed a ssn high 650 yds! LF comes off a 31-19 (-17*) win over Tenn. The Gators led 31-7 4Q and allowed 2 garbage time td's in the last 5:33. The Gators are +122 ypg while LSU is -53. QB Trask is hitting 71% completions w/a 38-3 ratio and faced LSU's pass D that allows 313 pass ypg and is #84 in our pass D rankings. LSU had their top WR Terrace Marshall opt out prior to LW's game and with such a depleted roster they won't be able to keep up with the Gators weapons. HC Mullen is 7-2-1 as a HF but style points don't matter, the Gators have Bama on deck and HC Orgeron is 6-0 as an AD so we think the Tigers stay within 3 td's.

North Carolina by 1 over MIAMI, FL - The home team is 7-1 ATS in this series. LY was Mack Brown's first ACC game and the Tar Heels (+5) got a late td to pull an outright upset, 28-25. The 'Canes absolutely destroyed Duke last week 48-0 (-14*). UM finished with a 524-177 yd edge and forced 5 TO's. NCar beat FCS Western Carolina 49-9 last week. The Heels are +131 ypg while UM is +79. The 'Canes avg 57 ypg more than their foes allow and QB King has a 20-4 ratio. NCar 106 ypg more than their foes allow and QB Howell has a 26-6 ratio. The Heels are +114 ypg on the road but they've lost 2 of their 4 road games. UM is 4-0 SU/3-1 ATS at home and are +126 ypg in those. Three of the 'Canes pass 4 wins are by 5 pts or less and we think this will be a close game so we'll call for the Tar Heels to pull the outright upset.

VIRGINIA TECH by 6 over Virginia - The Hokies are out for revenge after UVA finally took the Commonwealth Cup for the first time in 16 years LY. VT is 15-1 SU/11-5 ATS vs UVA. We went against VT last week for a 3H Key Selection on these pages then upgraded to our 5★ Dec GOM and won with the Hokies getting crushed 45-10 (+22) by Clemson. UVA is off a 43-32 (-3*) win over BC but they did allow 513 ypg to an Eagles squad that was missing their starting QB and RB. The Hokies are -24 ypg on the ssn and their defense allows foes to put up 26 ypg more than their avg. UVA is allowing 441 ypg and 12 ypg more than their opponents avg. Against 8 common foes, VT is 4-4 SU/3-5 ATS, -1 ppg & -9 ypg while UVA is 4-4 SU/6-2 ATS, -1 ppg & -38 ypg. The Hokies are at a 7-15 ATS run as chalk while UVA is 11-4 as a dog with 6 outright upsets the L/3 ssn but we also can't ignore the Hokies series dominance. LY we won our Totals GOY (Under 44 vs Pitt) in Bud Foster's last home game. Could we look at the Hokies for our Totals GOY again?

NEBRASKA by 7 over Minnesota - The home team and chalk are 4-0 ATS in this series. LY the Huskers put up just 299 yds and lost 34-7 (+7*). Minn was cancelled for the 2nd straight week last week. Neb got a blk'd punt and a long PR to set up td drives of 1 yd & 17 yds, jumping out to a 17-0 lead on Pur. The Huskers only led 34-27 4Q & finished with a +32 yd edge but won by 10 (+2). The Gophers had WR Bateman opt out prior to their game last week. Minn is -51 ypg and their defense allows 95 ypg more than their foes avg (first in FBS!). Neb avg 175 (4.4) rush ypg while Minn allows 216 (6.8). Neb's run D struggled in the first 3 games but they held Iowa to 129 (2.9) 2 weeks ago and LW gave up -2 rush yds vs Purdue. Minn is 3-6 as an AD while Neb is 3-7 as a HF. Neither team instills much confidence but this could be a high scoring game so we will look at the total!

NORTHWESTERN by 14 over Illinois - NW is 13-4 SU and on a 14-6 ATS run vs IL. The 'Cats have won 5 straight (4-1 ATS). The 'Cats were postponed last week and are still angry after losing 2 weeks ago at Minnesota. The Illini jumped out to a 14-0 lead against Iowa last week then allowed 35 pts before scoring a td in garbage time. NW only avg 328 ypg and they've been held under 300 ypg in 4 of their L/5 but those were against some of the top defenses in the Big 10 like Wisc & Iowa

and IL allows 77 ypg more than their foes avg. NW has already covered twice as home chalk this ssn including a 40 pt win over MD. This is a rivalry game though, so we'll only give the home favorite Wildcats a 2 touchdown lean.

BYU by 17 over San Diego St - These former WAC and MW rivals meet for the 38th time with BYU holding a 28-8-1 SU lead. LY despite BYU outgaining SDSt 416-269 (23-12 FD edge) SDSt came away with a 13-3 win as BYU had 3 TO's & missed 2 FG's. QB Wilson (2964, 73%, 27-3) leads a BYU OFF that is avg'g 523 yds & 45 pts TY. However this is the best DEF BYU will face as SDSt is only all'g 265 ypg/16 ppg and are holding foes to 108 ypg below their ssn avg. The difference here will be BYU's DEF vs SDSt's OFF. BYU is holding foes to 76 ypg under their ssn avg and the Aztec OFF is putting up just 263 ypg the L/4 gms (2 return TD's in win Colo St, 3★ LP winner on the Under 46.5!). SDSt is avg'g 204 rush yds (4.6) this season but BYU is holding tms to 108 rush ypg (3.3) but just gave up 281 (5.2) to CCar in an upset loss. SDSt is 4-2-1 ATS the L/4 as an AD but BYU is 6-1 ATS this ssn as a HF. BYU is off a loss & are just too talented & will eventually pull away to win by DD's.

ARMY by 7 over Navy - 121st meeting, Navy leads the series 61-52-7 & snapped Army's 3 gm win streak with a 31-7 win (396-148) LY. This will be the first year the Army/Navy game will not be played on a neutral field since 1943! Army has not played since Nov 21st (28-27 win vs GSthrn) while Navy has put up just 474 yds & 13 pts in their L/2 gms vs Tulsa & Mem. The Navy rush attack has not been as lethal (361 ypg, 6.1 ypc LY) as they are avg'g just 185 ypg (3.7) this ssn, but over the L/4 gms Army's run D has given up 164 ypg (5.1) after all'g just 83 rush ypg (2.8) their F/5 gms. Navy's run D has improved some (136 ypg, 3.9 the L/4 gms) but face a potent Army option that is avg'g 297 ypg (5.0 ypc). Defense will be the difference in this game & we will back Army & their strong DEF by a touchdown. Keep in mind this game has gone 'Under' 14 straight years and this game will CERTAINLY be in the mix for our Totals GOY!

WR by 6 over UCLA - Battle for the Victory Bell! USC leads the series 48-32-7 SU but UCLA has covered 5 of the last 8 meetings. USC needs a win here to secure a spot in the Pac-12 title game as they are 4-0 on the season led by QB Slovits (1257, 72%, 10-2, 5 td passes last wk!) and are avg'g 425 yds and 33 pts on the season. That USC offense goes up against a UCLA DEF giving up 373 ypg but have given up 525 yds to Colorado & 442 to Ariz St. UCLA sits at 3-2 on the ssn & their offense is a big reason why as they are avg'g 431 yds and 33 pts this season incl getting 228 rush ypg (5.1) led by RB Felton (578, 5.2). However QB Thomas-Robinson has missed the L/2 gms but bkp QB Griffin has filled in well. USC has played in close gms this ssn & we have been impressed with UCLA and think they can keep this Battle for Los Angeles close.

OREGON by 10 over Washington - Since '04 Oregon holds a 14-2 SU/ATS lead over Wash incl a 35-31 win last season as 2' point chalk on the road. After starting the season 3-0 Oreg has dropped their last 2 gms in narrow fashion losing by 3 pts to Oreg St (led 31-19 in 4Q) and 4 pts at Cal (-2 TO's). Wash nearly made it 4-0 last week but lost 31-26 vs Stanford (trailed 31-10 mid 3Q). Oreg's DEF has given up over 400 yds in 4 of their 5 games but face a Wash OFF that is avg'g 403 yds but failed to top 375 yds in either of their L/2 games. Despite losing QB Herbert to the NFL replacement QB Shough has hit 65% for 1389 (11-4) & RB Dye has 336 yds (7.4). Washington sits atop the P12 North but need a win here to clinch, while Oreg would tie Wash atop the standings with a win. We will back the series history in this one & call for a Ducks win by a td

WASHINGTON ST by 3 over California - Cal has won 12 of 15 games SU vs WSU since '05 and more recently have covered the last 3 meetings incl pulling the outright upset a year ago 33-20 as a 7' point dog. WSU played their first game last week since Nov 14th (loss at USC 38-13, -3 TO's) and are 1-2 on the year with their lone win coming at Oreg St in the ssn opener 38-28. Despite getting outgained 368-271 last wk vs Oregon, Cal came away with their 1st win of the season 21-17. Cal's OFF may be able to find some success against a WSU team that is all'g 440 ypg this ssn incl 309 pass ypg. WSU's OFF has found some success through the air in new HC Rolovich's 'Run n' Shoot' offense as they avg 246 ypg passing but Cal's pass D is only giving up 197 ypg & overall their D has held their L/3 foes to under 370 yds after all'g 440 yds in the opener. Cal's DEF could keep them in this one, but we see WSU coming away with a close win.

UAB by 11 over RICE - UAB is 3-0 SU and has covered 4 straight vs the Owls. The home team is 6-2 SU/7-1 ATS in this series. Last week we went with Rice as our Underdog POW as 23' pt dogs. Not only did they cover the Owls, but they won outright 20-0, holding Marshall to a ssn low 205 yds and had 5 int's (also a Big Dog outright winner at +1700, just \$9 on Thursdays, call 1-800-654-3448!). Rice was even missing QB Collins last week (check status). UAB hasn't played a game since Oct 31st but they still have a chance to play in the CUSA Title game and must in here. The Owls are +18 ypg while UAB is +70 ypg but only +30 ypg on the road. The Blazers aren't nearly as strong on the road as they are at home but they are still motivated and HC Clark is used to his team playing off long layoffs (2 year hiatus!). We will call for UAB to win but Rice stays within 2 touchdowns.

Over 38 years this play has been a reader favorite and now has a combined record of 58% winners over 38 years!! Outright upsets have been a major theme in recent years including 5 outright upsets TY after Rice beat Marshall last week 20-0 as 23' pt dogs! Here is this week's Underdog Play:

MISSISSIPPI ST +7' over Auburn

MISSISSIPPI ST (+) over Auburn - The home team is 3-0 SU/ATS in this series and Aub has won 3 of the L/4. Aub was beaten much worse than LW's final score indicated in their 31-20 home loss vs A&M. The Tigers were outgained 509-340 & held a 29-16 FD edge. MSU is fresh off a bye. The Bulldogs last 2 losses have been closer than expected, losing 31-24 against both UGA & Ole Miss. HC Leach's offense is showing improvement with QB Rogers completing 76% for 334 ypg and a 5-0 ratio since taking over full time. Aub is -29 ypg and QB Nix is 4-6 SU/5-5 ATS, hitting 54% w/an 11-12 ratio on the road. MSU's defense holds foes 41 ypg below their avg and they hold foes to 117 (3.3) rush ypg. We think the Bulldogs will limit the Aub run game and QB Rogers will have another solid effort against an Aub Def that allows 64% passing and 240 pass ypg. We scored an outright upset winner going against Aub for our Underdog POW earlier TY and we will try again with the Bulldogs who we think wins by a fgl. **FORECAST: MISSISSIPPI ST by 3**

LOUISVILLE by 3 over Wake Forest - The underdog is 6-0 ATS in this series and there has been 3 straight outright upsets. LY WF entered 5-0 with Clem on deck. Both tms had to use bkp QB's in the 2H yet they still combined to score the 2nd most points in ACC history in ULs 62-59 (+7) win. QB Hartman threw 2 TD's in relief and WF put up a ssn high 668 yds in the loss. Hartman enters w/an 8-0 ratio this year and WF avg 452 ypg and 16 ypg more than their foes allow. QB Cunningham has an 18-11 ratio but only 6-6 in his L/3 gms. The Cardinals D is allowing 371 ypg and hold foes 16 ypg below their avg. Against 3 common foes (UVA, VT, Cuse), WF is 3-0 SU/ATS, +16 ppg & +64 ypg. UL is 1-2 SU/ATS, +3 ppg and +156 ypg. WF is 5-1 ATS this year and is 11-4 as an AD. We will see reasons to go with both squads and ultimately give the home Cardinals a 3 point edge.

FLORIDA ST by 3 over Duke - Duke has not only never beaten FSU but they've never come closer than a 7 point loss (0-20 SU) and this is the smallest underdog they've ever been vs the 'Noles. This was supposed to be ply'd last week but Duke ply'd Miami instead and got crushed 48-0 (+14). FSU has had their last 2 games cancelled on gameday. The Blue Devils had another 5 TO's (-17 TO's on the ssn). FSU is -83 ypg but only -25 ypg at home. Duke is -53 ypg but +7 ypg on the road. The Blue Devils are allowing 17 ypg more than their foes avg but FSU allows 57 ypg more than their foes avg. While FSU is certainly in rebuilding mode, Duke's lopsided loss last week shows they are ready for the season to be over and we can't call for the first upset in series history.

Oklahoma by 14 over WEST VIRGINIA - OU is 8-0 SU vs WVU as B12 foes & have gone 5-0-1 ATS. OU is off a 27-14 win vs Baylor where they actually were outgained 288-269 while WVU was blown out 42-6 (outgained 483-263) at Iowa St. Before last week OU had avg'd 512 yds & 51 pts in their L/5 gms and face a WVU defense that went into last wk all'g just 284 ypg vs B12 foes. WVU did allow ISU to rush for 236 yds (5.4) and OU's OFF has been better since RB Stevenson (382, 5.9, 6 td in 4 gms) returned. WVU's OFF has been solid at times but have avg'd just 338 yds the L/3 gms & face an OU DEF that have held their L/3 foes to 260 ypg & 12 ppg. While OU has a berth in the B12 title game locked up, they definitely want to get their offense going again & can exploit WVU's DEF like ISU did last week. WVU is also just 1-4 ATS the L/2Y as a B12 HD & we'll back the Sooners by 2 TD's.

Coastal Carolina by 17 over TROY - 4th mtg as SBC foes. LY CCar was a home dog (+1) and scored a late td plus added the 2-pt conv to win 36-35. CCar is off a big win vs BYU while Troy is off a 29-0 win vs SAia. CCar has the SBC East locked up but likely still want their players to get reps before their big showdown vs the Cajuns. CCar run game (228 ypg/5.2 ypg) led by RB Marable (724 yds, 5.1) could have a big day vs a Troy run DEF that is all'g 211 ypg (4.5) their L/4 gms incl giving up 275 (7.2) to App St & 326 (5.3) to GSthrn. Over the L/3 SBC gms Troy is only avg'g 208 pass yds & CCar has the #41 pass D (187 ypg, 61% comp all'd vs SBC foes) led by CB Strong who has 5 int's. Troy's OL has only all'd 4 sks the L/4 gms but face a CCar pass rush that has 29 sks led by DE Jackson (8.5 sks). CCar is +151 ypg vs SBC foes while Troy is -18 ypg. CCar is 6-1 ATS vs SBC foes TY incl 2-0 as an AF & we don't see them having any hangover from last wk's big win.

Cincinnati by 6 over TULSA - For the 2nd year in a row the 2 teams that will square off in the AAC title gm will meet the week prior & UC was in that role LY! UC has not ply'd since their Nov 21st win at UCF while Tulsa won 19-6 and held Navy to just 153 yds. It will be a battle of strong DEF's as Tulsa comes in all'g just 328 ypg & are holding AAC foes to 96 ypg under their ssn avg while Cincy's DEF is all'g 308 ypg & are holding AAC foes to 173 ypg under their ssn avg! Cincy's OFF does have the edge over Tulsa led by QB Ridder (1821, 67%, 16-6, 526 rush, 7.9, 11 td) as they have put up 540 ypg & 45 ppg in their L/4, but Tulsa before their gm last wk was avg'g 461 ypg/34 ppg vs AAC foes & they got QB Smith back last wk. Against 4 common AAC foes Cincy is +168 ypg/+23 ppg while Tulsa is +54 ypg/+11 ppg, but Cincy has had extended time off & with these teams meeting next wk with much more at stake we expect a close game. Tulsa is also 5-1 ATS the L/2Y as an AAC dog.

Stanford by 3 over OREGON ST - Stanford has won the last 10 games SU (6-2-2 ATS) against Oregon St. After dropping their first 2 games, Stanford has picked up 2 straight wins incl a 31-26 win at Wash last week, but had to hold on to win (led 24-3 at HT). Oregon St comes in with a 2-3 record and fell last week at Utah 30-24, but they have covered 4 straight games. Oregon St's OFF is led by strong RB Jefferson (675, 7.4, 7 td) as they are putting up 194 rush ypg (5.5) their L/4 games. However QB Gebbia was hurt 2 wks ago and soph QB Nolan started last week (203, 53%, 1-1). That Oreg St OFF faces a Stanford DEF that is all'g 423 ypg (382 ypg the L/2 gms) and are giving up 201 rush ypg (5.2). The Oreg St defense has been their downfall this ssn as they have all'd 433 ypg & 32 ppg. They face a Stanford OFF that has put up 388 ypg, but did gain 443 last week & QB Mills faces an Oreg St pass D that has given up 226 ypg. However Oreg St has done a good job of keeping gms close & we think they do that again here.

Texas by 35 over KANSAS - While Tex is 15-1 SU vs KU since '97, KU has covered 6 of the L/8 mtgs. Texas is off a game vs KStt while KU is off a game vs Tex Tech. Texas is 5-3 SU in the B12 this ssn but still fell short of expectations while KU is 0-9 SU/2-7 ATS. KU is -231 ypg vs B12 foes and in 6 of their L/7 B12 gms have been outgained by at least 175 yds. Tex is -3 ypg this season vs B12 foes, as they have been up & down but could use this gm as a "get right" game to end the regular season behind Sr QB Ehlinger, who faces a KU DEF that allows 486 ypg/51 ppg vs B12 foes. Texas did however lose RB Ingram, LT Cosmi & S Sterns over the past week, but still won 69-31 over KStt last week (608 tll yds). While Texas may have nothing to play for in the B12 race, they still have the clear talent edge & we think they finish strong and win this gm by 5 td.

MEMPHIS by 3 over Houston - Mem is 4-0 SU/5-0 ATS vs UH. This gm was orig set to be played on Sept 18th. Mem is off a 35-21 loss at Tulane (4★ LP winner on Tulane!) while UH game was cancelled vs SMU & they have not played since Nov 14th. The Mem pass OFF led by QB White (2850, 60%, 26-8) is avg'g 342 pass yds vs AAC foes & the UH pass D comes in having given up just all'd 400 to BYU & 328 to UCF. After all'g 590 ypg the F/4 gms vs AAC foes Mem is only all'g 324 ypg the L/4 gms. The UH OFF was passing for 321 ypg the F/3 gms, but over the L/3 that dropped to 215 ypg. The Mem pass D struggled early (440 pass ypg all'd in F/4 gms) but vs the L/4 non-option tms they have all'd 228 pass ypg. We lean slightly with Mem as they are at home and Hou hasn't played in a month & are Mem is 2-0 ATS the L/3Y as an AAC home dog.

SERIES PLAY OF THE WEEK.....OREGON SITUATION PLAY OF THE WEEK.....AKRON REVENGE PLAY OF THE WEEK.....APPALACHIAN ST

Boise St by 9 over WYOMING - Dating back to 2002 Boise is 13-1 SU against WY (one loss was 30-28 in 2016) but WY has actually covered 4 of the L/5 mtgs incl LY when WY (+15') only lost 20-17 in OT. While Boise sits at 4-0 SU in the MW they have had their last 2 gms canceled (covid issues) while WY blew out UNLV (45-14, 498-290) 2 gms ago but suprisingly lost to NMex last week. WY features a run gm led by RB's Valladay (491, 5.6) & Smith (154 yds vs NMex, Valladay hurt LW, DNP) that is avg'g 247 yds (5.2) and their OL has all'd just 2 sks the L/2 gms. Boise though has given up 204 rush ypg (4.6) this ssn. Boise has avg'd 40 pts the L/3 gms but have only avg'd 367 yds in that span, as they have gotten great play from their ST units (KR Avery Williams 3 return td TY). The WY defense also has only all'd 295 ypg the L/4 gms. While Boise is 8-3 ATS the L/2Y as MW chalk WY is 7-2 ATS the L/5Y as a MW HD and it is unknown who could miss this game for Boise due to their covid issues.

Oklahoma St by 7 over BAYLOR - Baylor has had the upper hand in this series of late, winning 4 out of the L/5 gms SU/ATS. LY OSU (-4) hosted Baylor and had the FD edge (27-18) but had 3 TO's that led to 14 Baylor points and the Bears won 45-27. Baylor is off a loss vs Okla while OSU lost at TCU. Baylor's ssn has been rough under 1st year HC Aranda. BU's offense is avg'g just 330 yds this season & have all'd 26 sks. Baylor's DEF (355 ypg all'd) has kept them in many games as all 6 of their losses are by 13 pts or less & they held OU to 243 yds under their ssn avg. OSU's OFF does have some big-time weapons in RB Hubbard & WR Wallace but they have been banged up & OSU has been held to just 365 ypg over the L/4 gms. OSU's DEF has also all'd 501 ypg the L/3 gms, but that was vs OU, TTech, TCU and this BU OFF is getting held to 62 ypg under what their foes allow. OSU is just 3-6 ATS the L/3Y as a B12 AF & are on a 0-5 ATS slide, while BU is 3-5 ATS this ssn. While neither tm ply'g their best of late we think OSU is talented enough to come away with a td win.

TCU by 28 over Louisiana Tech - One prior meeting was the 2011 Poinsettia Bowl where TCU won 31-24. After starting 1-3 SU in B12 play TCU ended B12 play strong, going 4-1 SU/ATS incl a 29-22 win last wk vs Okla St (3★ LP winner on TCU). Despite going the month of Nov w/o playing a game LTech won at NTex 42-31 last wk. TCU's strength on OFF is their run game (245 ypg, 5.5 ypc) led by QB Duggan (513, 4.6, 9 td) and LTech's run D has all'd 214 rush ypg (4.4) the L/4 gms. TCU's DEF has come on strong, all'g just 347 ypg the L/4 gms & overall are holding foes to 38 ypg under their ssn avg & they face an LTech OFF putting up just 309 ypg the L/4 gms. While some may wonder the motivation level for TCU in this game, we think they will want to continue their momentum. We actually wonder how motivated LTech will be as they thought their ssn was over after last wk's game before this matchup was scheduled & have had several key players opt out.

COLORADO ST by 17 over Utah St - 77th meeting with Colo St holding a 39-35-2 SU lead, but recently CSU has covered the L/4 games. USU is having a season to forget as they are just 1-5 SU/ATS on the season and have had multiple players leave & HC Andersen was fired mid-ssn. USU is avg'g just 276 yds and 16 pts on offense. Colo St has only played 4 games this ssn and are just 1-3 SU/ATS on the season. The Rams are just avg'g 324 yds & 22 pts on OFF this ssn, but their DEF has played better of late, giving up just 269 ypg in their L/2 gms. CSU has been on the wrong end of several ST plays this ssn as they had 3 kicks (2 punts, 1 FG) blk'd vs Boise that were ret'd for TD's & Sdst ret'd a punt & kick for TD last week. While CSU is just 1-5 ATS the L/4Y as a MW HF, we don't mind leaning with the Rams as USU is on a 2-8 ATS slide as a MW dog the L/3Y.

HAWAII by 20 over Unlv - Hawaii leads the series 17-12 SU and as of '17 these tms play for the Island Showdown Trophy. LY UH (-7) won 21-7. Both tms are under 1st year HC's but this ssn has gone differently for both schools as UH is 3-4 SU/ATS while UNLV is 0-5 SU/ATS and just had their last gm canceled. UH's offense is avg'g just 380 yds & 24 pts this season but face a UNLV DEF that has all'd 485 ypg their L/4 gms & are giving up 59 ypg more than what their foes avg. Against 5 common foes UH is -20 ypg/-4 ppg but UNLV is far worse at -169 ypg/-21 ppg. Even in a rivalry game we don't know how motivated UNLV will be coming into their last gm without a win & having to make the trip out to Hawaii.

Alabama by 34 over ARKANSAS - Bama has won the last 13 in this series but Ark is 3-2-1 ATS. The home tm is 7-3-1 ATS. We've used Bama in each of the last 2 wks as LP plays in their wins over Aub & LSU. The Tide were -29' on the road last week but LSU was still no match, jumping to a 45-14 lead at half and winning 55-17. Ark was 3 pt dogs last week ply'g DC Odum's former squad Mizzou. The Hogs led 40-26 4Q but their defense failed down the stretch and MO got a GW fg on the final play of reg. Ark allowed a ssn high 653 yds and 37 FD's! If Ark couldn't stop MO we can't imagine what Bama's high powered offense might do. QB Jones has a 27-3 ratio and WR Smith has 749 yds in just his last 4 games! Bama is putting up 163 ypg more than their foes allow while Ark is allowing 32 ypg above their avg. Bama has the SEC Title gm on deck so we'll only give the Tide a 5 td lean.

Tennessee by 14 over VANDERBILT - Vandy has won 5 of the last 8 mtgs, are 7-1 ATS and those 5 wins have come by 16.2 ppg. Tenn enters off a school record 6 straight losses. HC Pruitt gave true frosh QB Harrison Bailey his first career start last week and the Vols led 7-3 2Q before FL took control. The Vols were down 31-7 4Q when JT ShROUT came in and threw 2 td passes in garbage time to get Vols backers a backdoor cover, 31-19 (+17'). Vandy had their gm vs UGA ppd last week. This will be interim HC Todd Fitch's debut. QB Bailey should have success throwing against a Vandy defense that allows 74% completions and 293 ypg. Vandy is only 3-11 as a HD and the Vols do have a significant talent edge so we will call for the Vols to end their losing streak and beat the 'Dores by 2 td's.

Georgia by 9 over Missouri - MO has lost 6 str in this series including LY 27-0 (+17') but they did cover 4 straight prior. UGA had their game postponed last week while MO took their winning streak to 3 games by beating rival Ark 50-48 while putting up a ssn high 653 yds! The Tigers have won 5 of their last 6 games and are +105 ypg in those. UGA has topped 400 yds in each of JT Daniels 2 starts at QB including a ssn high 471 yds 2 weeks ago vs SCar. The Dawgs hold foes 71 ypg below their avg but they do give up 66% completions. QB Bazelak has a 5-2 ratio and threw for 380 yds last week vs Ark. The Tigers are one of the hottest teams in the SEC and HC Drinkwitz has them playing their best at home where they are 3-0 as home dogs with 2 outright upsets. We won't call for the upset but we will call for MO to keep within single digits.

SEA has dominated their recent matchups against the Jets w/a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS mark and a 14 pt avg MOV. With the Jets being outscored (-19 ppg) and outgained (-128 ypg) by substantial margins in their 5 AG's TY (0-5 SU/1-4 ATS) and former NY safety Jamal Adams looking for some paycheck, we'll give a substantial lean to the home team here (NYJ 1-4 ATS run as an AD) as they get back on track after LW's surprising loss. **FORECAST: SEATTLE by 23**

3★ LAS VEGAS over Indianapolis - This marks the 1st of 3 consec home matchups for the Raiders who return to Vegas following a final second victory against the Jets where rookie WR Ruggs pulled in the GW 46-yd TD pass (LV 440-376 yd edge). IND meanwhile heads into NDIV action before taking on HOU for a 2nd time in a 3-gm span next week at home (3★ Newsletter Winner on IND LV, 6 pt win over HOU). In their road trip to IND a ssn ago, the Raiders (+6) picked up a 31-24 upset win over the Colts. With LV having covered 4 of their L6 coming in, we'll lean with them in this one against a sandwiched Colts squad. **FORECAST: LAS VEGAS by 7**

OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ JACKSONVILLE (+) over Tennessee - The Titans ran into a speed bump on their way towards the AFC South title a week ago at home against CLE who jumped out to a 38-7 HT lead in the eventual 6 pt victory. The Jags meanwhile dropped their 11th straight contest LW in MIN although the Vikings did need a short FG in the final minutes of OT (JAX led 16-6 early 3Q, 4-2 TO deficit). In their 1st meeting of the ssn way back in Wk 2, the Titans (-7) knocked off the Jags for the 6th time in 7 tries thanks to a GW 49-yd FG w/1:36 left. Despite the losing streak, JAX has actually picked up covers in 4 of the L5 coming in while going 7-1 ATS as a DIV HD. With TEN failing to cover all 3 TY when listed as an AF (1 & 2 pt SU wins, 11 pt SU loss), we're calling for the home squad to keep this closer than expected. **FORECAST: Tennessee by 1**

OTHER PLAYS

New England at LA RAMS - Thursday - Rematch of SBXXXVI and SBLIII (NE won both including in the '18 ssn which was the lowest score in "Big Game" history). The Patriots are right back inside of SoFi Stadium following a shocking 45-0 victory over the Chargers (2★ Newsletter Winner!). The Rams meanwhile picked up a 10 pt win in the desert against the Cardinals (29-17 FD & 463-232 yd edges). The Patriots have dominated this series since that 1st SB win with a perfect 6-0 SU mark (5-1 ATS) and a 15 pt avg MOV. The Rams however have covered 5 of their L7 home matchups coming in. **We'll have one of our Marquee selections available after Noon EST on gameday.**

Green Bay by 13 over DETROIT - Following a 34-30 comeback win in CHI in the 1st gm with interim HC Bevel (DET 460-389 yd edge), the Lions return to Ford Field to take on a Packers squad that saw another big effort from QB Rodgers (295 pass yds, 3 TD's) in a 14 pt victory. In their 1st matchup of the ssn way back in Wk 2, the Packers (-6) won for a 3rd consec time against the Lions with a 488-307 yd edge in the 21 pt victory. With DET failing to cover 8 of their L9 as a DIV HD and the Packers on a 7-3 ATS run vs the NFC North, the visitor gets the solid edge in this one.

Dallas by 1 over CINCINNATI - Following a Tuesday night trip to BAL due to Covid issues (game was orig scheduled to be plyd the prior Thur), the Cowboys and former Bengals QB Dalton (spent 1st 9 yrs in the NFL there) head to CIN for their final AG of the ssn. An early 72 yd TD pass was all the Bengals offense could muster up LW in South Beach in MIA's 19-7 victory (3★ LP Winner on Under 43!). While the Bengals have dropped 3 straight in this series (1-2 ATS) with an 8 pt avg margin of defeat, their 8-4-1 current ATS run and the Cowboys' 1-6 ATS mark in AG's (as of presstime) has us taking the points in this one.

Arizona by 6 over NY GIANTS - The Cardinals have picked up 3 consec SU wins and covers (13 pt avg MOV) including a 27-21 win here at MetLife a ssn ago (NYG 263-245 yd edge). They do however head East following a 10 pt defeat in the desert against the Rams who finished with solid FD (29-17) and yard (463-232) edges. The Giants meanwhile picked up the biggest upset in 2020 with a 17-12 victory in SEA with bkp QB McCoy under center (Top Play 3.5★ Winner on Under 47!). With the Giants failing to cover 12 of their L15 as a HD and the Cardinals going 8-3 ATS in NDIV AG's, we'll go ahead and call for ARZ to get back on track and get the cover here as they try to stay alive in the NFC playoff race.

Houston by 3 over CHICAGO - The Bears losing streak moved to 6 straight LW at home against the Lions who got a GW 5-yd TD run w/1:37 left (DET 460-389 yd edge). The Texans meanwhile nearly pulled off the outright upset at home vs IND before a costly fumble at the Colts 2-yd line in the final 2 minutes (3★ Newsletter Winner on IND!). HOU is a perfect 4-0 SU/ATS all-time against the Bears with an 11 pt avg MOV. With the struggling Bears also going 0-5-1 ATS in recent meetings with the AFC, the visitor gets the FG lean in this one.

CAROLINA by 7 over Denver - Rematch of SB50, a contest that saw the underdog Broncos pick up a 24-10 upset victory in Peyton Manning's last career game. These 2 also met to start the '16 ssn with DEN overcoming a 17-7 HT deficit to win by 1. The Broncos dropped their 4th contest in the L5W in Arrowhead against the Chiefs although they did keep KC out of the EZ until 1:06 left in the 3Q (6 pt loss as a 13' pt dog). The Panthers meanwhile return to action following a late ssn bye week. With CAR picking up covers in 12 of their L17 against AFC foes along with an overall 7-3 ATS run coming in, we'll go ahead and call for the well-rested home squad to get a win in this one.

TAMPA BAY by 3 over Minnesota - The Vikings earned a tough OT victory as heavy chalk LW at home against the Jaguars with a GW 23-yd FG w/1:49 left in the extra frame. The Bucs meanwhile are back at home following a late ssn bye week. After a 5-gm SU/ATS losing streak against the Bucs from '02-'12, the Vikings have picked up wins and covers in the past 2 meetings ('14 & '17) with a 13 pt avg MOV. With MIN also covering 4 consec AG's (incl 2 outright upsets), we're keeping the Bucs lean at just a FG here as they've gone just 1-8-2 ATS as a NDIV HF.

Kansas City by 4 over MIAMI - After their only HG in a 5-wk span a week ago against the Broncos where they overcame a 16-12 deficit late in the 3Q, the Chiefs head to South Beach to take on a Dolphins squad that's won their L2 contests against the Jets and Bengals by a combined 39-10 margin (3★ LP Winner on Under 43 CIN/MIA). The Chiefs have come out victorious in each of the past 2 matchups in this series including a 29-13 (-10) Arrowhead win back in '17. While they are also on a solid 12-7 ATS run dating back to LY, we like the home squad to keep this one tighter than expected as the Dolphins are 13-6-1 ATS as a NDIV HD and have covered 9 of their L11 overall.

LA CHARGERS by 3 over Atlanta - After a 2nd loss to the Saints in a 3-wk span (outgained 424-332 in 5 pt defeat, 2 late drives stopped in Saints territory), the Falcons head West to take on a Chargers squad that was destroyed at home by the Patriots (held to just 258 yds in the 45-0 loss). Following a 6-gm losing skid against the Falcons that went from 1991-2012, the Chargers (+5) picked up a 33-30 OT victory in their trip to ATL back in '16. While the Chargers have failed to cover 10 of their L13 NDIV HG's, we'll give them a FG lean here as ATL has gone just 3-13 ATS in non-conf matchups.

New Orleans by 10 over PHILADELPHIA - This marks the only HG in a 4-wk span for the Eagles who struggled LW in Lambeau against the Packers with rookie QB Hurts (5-12-109-1-1) taking over for the ineffective Wentz. The Saints meanwhile moved to a perfect 3-0 SU/ATS with bkp QB Hill under center as they knocked off the Falcons for a 2nd time in 3 weeks. The Saints and Eagles met on 2 occasions during the '18 ssn with NO picking up a 48-7 win in the regular ssn and a 20-14 victory in the playoffs. With the Saints on a 17-5 ATS run in recent AG's and PHI continuing to battle injuries and inconsistency on both sides of the ball (Hurts starting here?), we have no issue giving the visitor the edge in this one.

SAN FRANCISCO by 2 over Washington - This game will be played in Arizona due to Covid regulations in Santa Clara. Both squads head into this desert matchup on short rest following their respective MNF matchups a week ago.
