4★ Stanford over VANDERBILT - 1st mtg. After getting beat by Kansas St in their opener, Stanford looked like a completely different team last week in their 42-28 (+17) win over USC, also giving us our first Big Dog outright winner of the season at +650 (Just \$12 on Thursdays, call 1-800-654-3448). The Cardinal switched to QB McKee who threw for 234 and 2 td's. A week after getting embarrassed in their opener by FCS East Tenn St, Vanderbilt was an SEC road dog vs Colo St and won 24-21 (+7) but they were still outgained 445-342 and trailed 14-0 2Q. The Cardinal are making their first trip to an SEC stadium. David Shaw is 21-13-1 as an AF and Vandy is 3-12 as a HD. Stanford won't take it easy after their season opening loss and we like the Cardinal to win the battle of the smart kids by 3 touchdowns! FORECAST: Stanford by 21

3★ OKLAHOMA over Nebraska - These former Big 12 foes have met 86 times dating back to 1912! OU leads the all-time series 45-38-3 but have not met since the 2010 Big 12 Title Game where OU won 23-20. This is OU's 3rd straight home game while Neb travels to Norman after 2 straight home gms against FCS Fordham & an inexp'd Buffalo team where they won 28-3 last wk (2★ PS winner upgraded to a 3★ LP winner on Neb!). Neb's pass D has all'd opposing QB's to hit 61% this ssn & now face one of the best QB's in the country in Rattler who has thrown for 547 (77%, 6-2) in his F/2 gms. Neb also had issues with their OL vs ILL (5 sks all'd) and now face a talented OU DL that has collected 8 sks this ssn in 2 gms. While OU comes in on an 11-16 ATS run as a DD favorite Neb is just 2-6 ATS off a SU win since 2019. Another reason why we like OU to win big is that there were reports Neb tried to get out of playing this gm & we think OU will try to pour it on the Huskers

FORÉCAST: OKLAHOMA by 31 3★ GEORGIA ST over Charlotte - Home team is 0-2 in previous meetings including in 2015 when UC picked up their first ever FBS win, beating GSt 23-20 (+7'). The 49ers enter 2-0 after beating Duke in the opener for their first ever Power 5 win, then beat FCS Gardner Webb 38-10 (-23) last week. GSt is in the opposite shape, having lost their F/2 to Army & North Carolina by 33 & 42 points (0-2 ATS). The Panthers were crushed last week 59-17 at NCar, and outgained 607-271 but they only actually trailed 24-10 at half (204-140 yds). RB Destin Coates topped 100 yards in 5 of 8 games LY but only has 58 (2.4) in his first 2 this year. He should have a much better outing against a 49ers D that allowed 352 (8.0) rush against Duke in the opener. The Panthers have a significant experience edge (#16 vs #113) and this is a big step down in competition, plus they got back some missing starters last week. Georgia St is a better than than their record indicates and we will call for **FORECAST: GEORGIA ST by 10** the Panthers to win by more than a touchdown OTHER SELECTIONS

2★ Coastal Carolina over BUFFALO - First meeting. Both teams ended the '20 ssn ranked in the AP Top 25 but enter the '21 ssn in 2 completely different situations. CCU brings back 19 st'rs & are #17 in exp while UB lost their HC, their OFF/DEF coord's, and return 10 st'rs (#114 exp). CCU is off a 49-22 home win against Kansas while UB played at Nebraska last wk & fell 28-3. CCU has balanced offense led by QB McCall & are avg'g 535 ypg/51 ppg and face a UB defense with just 6 st'rs back & they just gave up 516 yds to Neb last week. CCU QB McCall has hit 83% the F/2 gms while the rush attack is avg'g 239 ypg (6.6). CCU is all'g 324 ypg/18 ppg and they collected 6 sks last wk vs KU. UB has gone 5-0 ATS s/17 as a home dog, but this is not the same Bulls team of years past & CCU is 3-1 ATS as an AF since HC Chadwell took over full-time. We think the experience factor will play a huge role here & see this exp'd CCU squad going into Buffalo and getting the road win by over 2 td's.

FORECAST: COASTAL CAROLINA by 17 2★ Middle Tennessee (+) over UTSA - Last year MT was 0-2 off B2B blowout losses and gave up 40 & 14 yd td drives to trail 14-3 1Q vs UTSA last year. The Blue Raiders got within 8 then scored a td late 4Q but missed the 2 pt conv and lost 37-35 (+6'). MT is off a 21 point loss at VTech last week but the Blue Raiders only trailed 14-7 at half with a +8 yd edge and was only outgained 383-349. UTSA overpowered FCS Lamar last week 54-0 (-37'). UTSA's upset over Illinois doesn't look as impressive after the Illini were routed at Virginia while MT was competitive against Virginia Tech. MT is 6-3 ATS as a CUSA road dog with 3 outright upsets the last 3 years and this is the first time UTSA is laying double-digits under HC Traylor so we think the Blue Raiders stay within a touchdown

L'ville only has 6 starters back on defense but we give them a slight defensive edge and they've got a solid ST's edge as well. UCF is 4-0 SU/ATS in road openers including a 28 point win just last year at ACC foe Georgia Tech. The Knights are 4-7 as an AF but UL is 4-7-2 as an underdog under Satterfield. Maryland at ILLINOIS - Only the second-ever meeting between these two B10 combatants, the first being a beatdown of the Fighting Illini by Maryland. Illinois was on the road (+17') and manged to fall behind 49-12 late 3Q before ultimately surrendering 63 pts in a 30-pt blowout back in '18. The Terps racked up 712 yds of offense while setting a school record for points in a B10 game. After their impressive start to '21 with an outright upset of Nebraska at home, Illinois is 0-2 ATS after an outright upset loss to UTSA at home and a 4 TD hammering at Virginia. Maryland has been impressive, including their opening outright upset of WV at home (+2'). QB Taulia Tagovailoa has been excellent for the Terrapins, averaging almost 10 yds per attempt (606, 76%, 6/0 in 2 gms). SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 18TH

MIAMI, FL by 13 over Michigan St - Miami is 4-0 SU in this series but they haven't met since 1989. The 'Canes barely avoided an 0-2 start last week when they beat App State with a late fg then got a SOD to win 25-23 (-8). D'Eriq King has hit 68% in 2 gamés but just a 1-2 ratio. Mich St pulled an upset over NW in week 1 then beat Youngstown St 42-14 (-27'). QB Peyton Thorne has a 5-0 ratio

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and RB Kenneth Walker has 321 yds and an amazing 10.7 ypc (264 vs NW). Miami held Bama and App St to under 4.0 ypc (137 ypg, 3.6). The 'Canes have a solid experience edge (#8 vs #90), and they've got the edge in all 3 phases. Mich St has been impressive in their first 2 games, but NW only had 8 starters back and they played an FCS team while Miami is already battle tested. The Canes are 3-10 when favored by 7+ points but Mich St is 4-11 ATS off a SU win and we think the south Florida heat will wear the Spartans out. Miami has won 12 straight Non Conf home games vs FBS foes (8-3-1 ATS) and we think they take another by double-digits.

MICHIGAN by 24 over Northern Illinois- Just the second-ever meeting between Mich and the

Huskies. NIU traveled to the Big House in '05 (+18') and hung tough with the Wolverines before falling 33-17. N. Illinois was winless SU LY in a MAC-only slate but managed to go 2-1 ATS as AD. The Huskies then kicked off '21 by upsetting Georgia Tech 22-21 (+19). NIU made a huge rally last week, trailing 42-16 3Q then scored 27 straight before allowing WY's go-ahead td w/1:35 left. The Huskies finished with a 477-395 yd edge. While Mich also struggled to throw the ball LW (44 yds) they did finish with a 353-40 yd rushing edge, in their 31-10 (-6') win over Washington. NIÙ is 7-2 as an away dog and are getting 4 td's here so we think the Huskies keep it within the opening line. ARMY by 40 over Connecticut - last met in '15 when UConn won 22-17 with Army getting the backdoor cover as a 7 pt AD. UConn didn't play LY, has had a tough ssn going 0-3 SU despite an FCS foe & are 0-3 ATS despite being a dog of 27' & 34'. LW the Huskies were outgained by Purdue 562-223 & out FD'd 29-11. Black Knights are in the middle of a 3 gm home stand. After dominating Georgia St i43-10 as a 2' pt AD, they looked to be on their way to a easy win LW up 35-14 4Q as a 6' pt HF but allowed WKU 3 td's in L/8:05 (L/w:22) & only won 38-35 thanks to a 31 yd fg w/1:52 left. As UConn is #130 in both Off & Def, Army has the edge in both especially of defense (#38). Army is avg 299 ypg rush & 4.5 ypc while UConn is allowing 190 ypg rush & 4.3 ypc. Knight's are avg 41 ppg while UConn is allowing 44 ppg & have been shutout by both FBS foes. Army could make that straight, especially with LW's almost 4Q collapse fresh on their minds

Eastern Michigan by 21 over UMASS - UMass is 2-0 SU & ATS vs EM with wins in '14 & '15 as MAC foes but this is EM first trip Amherst. After just failing to cover as a 26 pt AD LW at Wisc (lost 34-7), EM opened as a DD AF. Since '16 EM is 11-0 SU but just 6-5 ATS as a DD favorite including 1-1 on the road but did beat Akron 42-14 as a 17 pt AF in 19. This is the Minutemen's 11th straight game as a DD dog. This however is the first of those 11 games being a dog of less than +23' as 9 were 31 pts or more. They are 0-10 SU but 4-5-1 ATS in the previous 10 incl 1-1 ATS Tas they covered LW vs Boston College, losing 45-28 as a 37 pt HD. LW UMass only trailed 14-0 at HT & never trailed by more than 21 which gives us some line value here as 2 of their 3Q td's were off BC fumbles including a fumbled punt recovered at the BC1. EM has the edges on both offense (#92-#126) & defense (#101-#129) & should be able to get the job done here.

Boston College by 21 over TEMPLE - BC leads the all-time series vs their former Big East

foes 29-7-2. Temple was gifted the pleasure of taking on Akron LW after being dismanteld in their opener at Rutgers 61-14 (+14'). Despite falling behind 14-0 on the road to the Zips, Temple got great QB play from true freshman Justin Lynch (19-23-245-2-0) and the Owls secured the victory 45-24 (-6'), playing w/o Georgia transfer and starting QB D'Wan Mathis (PS#12). The Eagles have not lost to a non-Power 5 team since UCF in '11, who hardly qualifies as a non-Power 5 opponent (especially given the move to the Big 12), and is 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS in their last 6 meetings with the Owls. While Temple covered in their last matchup in '18, the Owls are just 2-6 ATS in home openers and the visitors are 4-0 ATS in this series. We expect Boston College to win by 3 TDs.

WEST VIRGINIA by 3 over Virginia Tech - Former Big East rivals meet for just the 2nd time since 2005. VT has won 3 straight meetings including in '17 31-24 (-4). WV bounced back from their week 1 loss to MD and beat FCS Long Island 66-0 (-48'). The Hokies were in a sandwich game vs Middle Tenn last week after upsetting NCarolina in their opener. The Hokies only led 13-6 at half and finished with just a 383-349 yd & 24-20 FD edges but MT did score their last td with :27 left for a 35-14 (-20) final. VT is actually -12 ypg in their first two games. The Mountaineers have been tough at home, going 6-0 SU/5-1 ATS since last year in Milan Puskar Stadium (only non-cover was by 1/2 point). VT is 7-1 SU/5-3 ATS in road openers but have failed to cover their last 2. WV is 4-1 as a HF and we used the Mountaineers last year for our first 5★ and they came through with an upset over Baylor. Could we go back to WVU for this year's September 5★?

PITTSBURGH by 14 over Western Michigan- First meeting. Pitt is off a road win over SEC foe Tennessee. The Panthers trailed 10-0 1Q thanks to a blocked punt but led 41-27 4Q. Pitt only led 41-34 late 4Q and got a SOD and an int on the Vols L/2 possessions. WMich held a 407-57 yd edge over Illinois St last week in their 28-0 (-11') win. The Broncos are 0-6 SU/1-5 ATS on the road vs Power-5 foes, losing by 27 ppg including a 47-14 loss at Michigan in week1. Pitt is just 3-9-1 as a Double-Digit favorite and they are off an emotional win. The Panthers only have New Hampshire on deck but it's hard to trust either team in their given role. We think the Broncos will be motivated to be more competitive against a Power-5 this time but Pitt has a veteran QB and could possibly start 5-0 so we've got Pitt winning by 2 td's.

Cincinnati by 3 over INDIANA - The Hoosiers lead the all-time series 9-3-2, including winning 4 in a row and 7 of the last 9 in Bloomington. Indiana recovered nicely by trouncing FCS Idaho 56-14 LW after their opening nightmare at lowa, having lost 34-6 after getting crushed under the weight of three 1H INTs (2 pick-sixes) by QB Penix Jr. The gm was much more evenly contested than the final score indicated, and the D played well, allowing just 303 total yds to the Hawkeyes. Cincinnati meanwhile have yet to be tested after rolling Miami (OH) at home in their opener 49-14 (-23) and taking care of FCS Murray St 42-7. The Bearcats have a bye on deck before their trip to South Bend, and this 2-game stretch is vital to their CFP aspirations. We believe the Bearcats scrape this game out by just a FG.

TEXAS A&M by 35 over New Mexico- A&M is 4-0 all-time vs New Mexico and won the last meeting 55-14 (-17") in '17. Our Early Bird comp play took a hit last week when A&M lost QB Haynes King to an injury in the 1Q vs Colorado. Backup Zach Calzada hit just 47% and fumbled as he crossed the goal line but did lead a 77 yard td drive late 4Q as the Aggies pulled out a 10-7 (-17). NM is 2-0 after beating an FCS squad and New Mex St last week, 34-25 (-19'). The Lobos did have a 559-345 yd edge but missed 2 fg's and were SOD 3 times including at the NMSt 1 and 7. The Aggies are 9-4 ATS in non-conference under Fisher. They are in a Power 5 sandwich with Arkansas on deck but they've covered their L/2 in sandwich situations. NM is just 1-8 ATS on the road vs Power 5 foes and while they did add Kentucky transfer Terry Wilson (6-0, 73%), the Aggies have held Kent St & Colorado to just 298 yds (49%, 100 pass ypg). If A&M needs to start Calzada, he should be better with a week to prepare so we don't mind laying big points here

COLORADO By 3 over Minnesota - 3rd-ever mtg, with Colorado coming away with each victory. LW was a bit of a surprise for both teams, as The Buffs lost 10-7 (+17) to #5 Texas A&M in Denver, and while technically a neutral site, we're inclinded to believe for obvious reasons that Colorado maintained an altitude edge as they finished with the same amount of FDs as the Aggies (14) and were just -28 in the yd edge. The Golden Gophers seemed to experience an emotional letdown after watching their best player, RB Mo Ibrahim, go down for the year with an apparent achilles rupture. RB Treyson Potts did have 178 yds rushing, but the rest of Minnesota had -3 yds on the ground and held on for a 31-26 win at home vs Miami (OH) (-18'), having been outgained 341-287. We think Minn will have a tough time handling the altitude and the Buffs have been impressive

WYOMING by 10 over Ball St - First ever meeting. Wyoming faced a MAC tm LW and went up on NIU 42-16 but then would trail 43-42 before coming back to win 50-43 (3★ newsletter winner!). WY now faces a tough Ball St team that returns 20 st'rs from their MAC title team a yr ago. BSU is off a physcial game at Penn St where they lost 44-13 (295-493) & now must travel out west. This ssn WY is avg'g 171 rush ypg (3.9) but all'd 477 yds last wk however WY's D is exp'd with all 11 st'rs back BSU all'd 140 rush ypg (4.0) a ssn ago, but will face a talented stable of RB's led by Valladay. BSU does have an exp'd offense led by QB Plitt & talented WR's, but WY does have a exp'd set of DB's. BSU is 8-2 ATS the L3Y as an underdog, however WY has a significant home field edge here with the altitude (7,220 ft) on their side and a team not used to those conditions such as BSU may get the altitude (7,220 ft) on their side and ā team not used to those conditions such as BSU may get worn down in the 2H especially against a physcial WY team. WY is also 10-5 ATS as a HF since '16. **Nevada by 4 over KANSAS ST** - First mtg. Nev is off to a 2-0 start that included a win at Cal 22-17. KSt's D has recorded 10 sks in 2 gms but Nev has allowed just 2 sks on 85 pass att. KSt is rushing for 204 ypg (5.1) & Nev did allow 153 (5.7) to Cal, however Nev does have a veteran DL and they face a KSt OL that all'd 3 sks on 14 pass att two wks ago vs Stanford. KSt did lose to Ark St at home IV but will have the full crowd behind them, however Nev is one of the most did lose to Ark St at home LY but will have the full crowd behind them, however Nev is one of the most exp'd teams in the country (#7). We will call for Nev to get their 2nd road win vs a P5 team this ssn. NOTRE DAME by 10 over Purdue - Notre Dame leads the all-time series 56-26-2 with their in-state rvials. Purdue has been impressive to start the yr, going 2-0 SU and ATS after a home win against Oregon St (-7) and going on the road to beat up hapless UConn 49-0 (-35). QB Jack Plummer has been as advertised (558, 74%, 6/0 in 2 gms), but has yet to go up against a secondary this talented. AA Safety Kyle Hamilton had two INTs in the opener vs. Florida St and presents a possible matchup problem for Purdue talented WRs. The Fighting Irish (-7) won by a FG in OT after giving up an 18-bt 4Q lead to FSU. In their home opener, ND trailed Toledo 29-24 (-16') with 1:09 to play before QB Coan's TD pass to put the Irish ahead, who won 32-29. The Fighting Irish haven't played their best game yet and they will be up for an in-state rival so we've got Notre Dame by double-digits. CLEMSON by 31 over Georgia Tech - Clemson is 6-0 SU/5-0-1 ATS including a 73-7 (-27) whip-

Clemson is off a 49-3 (-50) win over FCS S Carolina St. GT is also off a win over an FCS foe, beating Kennesaw St 45-17 (-19'). The Jackets loss in the opener to Northern Illinois was deceiving, considering they finished with a 412-272 yd edge and lost QB Sims in the 2Q. The Jackets didn't get Sims back last week but Jordan Yates has a 5-0 ratio in 2 games. Clemson has a huge edge on defense and QB Uiagalelei should have a big day against GT's pass defense who allowed over 300 pass yards on 4 occasions. GT's strength is their run game but Clemson only allowed 121 (3.9) vs UGA. The Tigers are on a 20-7-1 ATS run in ACC play and they've covered 7 of their L/10 ACC openers. In 2018 we used Clemson over GTech as our September 5★ and the Tigers rolled to a 49-21 (-16) win so we might just go back to this matchup again!

The Cougs on the other hand were able to get past FCS foe Portland St a week ago in Pullman with a 20 pt win as QB de Laura would throw for 303 yds & 3 TD's in his 1st start of the ssn. While WSU has only won 10 of the 74 meetings all-time against USC, two of those victories have come in the L/5 including a 30-27 (+4') home win over the #5 ranked Trojans (ended WSU's 15-gm home losing streak vs ranked tms). With the Cougars covering just 1 of their past 5 matchups inside of the P12 and the Trojans covering each of their past 4 as road chalk coming in, we're calling for the visitor to get back on track in this one.

Alabama by 24 over FLORIDA - First reg season meeting since 2014 with the last 3 mtgs coming in the SEC Title game including last year when Bama held off the Gators 52-46 (-17). The Tide have won 7 straight meetings (5-2 ATS). Bama kept it vanilla against FCS Mercer last week, "only" winning 48-14 (-54). The Tide already have a 31 point win over Miami under their belt and they've covered 8 straight reg season games vs FBS foes. FL finished with a 666-283 yd edge over USF last week, led 35-3 at half but only won 42-20. QB Emory Jones has just a 2-4 ratio but they've rushed for 382 (8.5) ypg, with Jones and bkp QB Richardson their top 2 rushers. Bama held Miami and D'Eriq King to just 87 (2.8) rush in their opener so we have to imagine Florida will need to find some game to compete with Bama. This is Bryce Young's first true road test but he handled Miami just fine and Florida's lack of passing concerns us We can't no against the Tide here.

WAKE FOREST by 3 over Florida St - FSU is 7-1 SU/5-2-1 ATS in this series. Hard to figure FSU who looked good in an overtime loss to Notre Dame in their opener, then lost to Jacksonville St 20-17 as nearly 4 td chalk on a hail mary. McKenzie Milton made his first start at FSU and first start since his devestating knee injury. He only finished 18-31-133-1-1. Noles could go back to dual threat QB Jordan Travis here. WF is 2-0 after easy wins over Old Dominion and Norfolk St. The Deacons only finished with a 413-336 yd edge last week against Norfolk St but the Spartans did get a garbage time td drive. WF is 9-5 as a HF and FSU is 1-3 as an AD but we can't get their opener out of our heads when they nearly knocked off Notre Dame. We think FSU has to circle the wagons so our lean is with the underdog but we can't call for the outright upset based on last week's performance.

IOWA by 24 over Kent St - Iowa is 2-0 SU & ATS vs Kent St but LTH then #19 Iowa needed a 4Q IR to to cover as a 30' pt HF in a 39-7 win. LW we won a 3★ Small College Late Phone play on Kent St -19 over VMI. an easy 60-10 win and cover (led 39-0 at HT). Iowa is off a 6th straight win over in-state Rival Iowa St 27-17 as a 4' pt AD. & are now ranked #5 in the AP. The Hawkeys are 24-4 all-time vs MAC teams incl 4 staight wins (3-1 ATS) but only covered by 1 over MAC foe Miami in '19 as a 23 pt HF. Under 4th yr HC Sean Lewis KS is 3-3 ATS vs P5 teams including allowing a frontdoor cover by then #6 Texas A&M losing 41-10 as a 29' pt AD despite only trailing 10-3 at HT. Kent St actually has the offensive edge (#11-#48) but Iowa has a Huge defensive edge (#4-#120). While you might expect a drop off after defeating their Rival, Iowa covered the last 2 the games after defeating ISU covering as an 18' pt HF in '18 & a 23 pt HF in '19.

OHIO ST by 23 over Tulsa- In their only previous meeting in '16, The Golden Hurricane (+28) traveled to Columbus to run into the #4 Buckeyes who simply overmatched them in a 48-3 blowout. Tulsa began their yr w/ a loss to FCS UC Davis but had 9 players suspended, 6 of which were for the entirity of the game, with four of those being starters. The Golden Hurricane rebounded against Oklahoma St in Stillwater LW (+11'), outgaining the Cowboys by +34 on their own turf while losing the FD edge by -1. Tulsa actually led 14-7 entering the 4Q but fell 28-23. OSU is coming off their first regular ssn loss under HC Ryan Day (-15) to an Oregon Ducks team that was w/o their best player in DE Kayvon Thibodeux. OSU piled up 612 yds of offense (+107) but were stopped on 4th down 3 times. We think The Golden Hurricane keep it within 4 td's.

Baylor by 22 over KANSAS - Baylor leads the series 16-4 overall & dating back to 2010 they have

won 11 straight games SU & are 10-1 ATS over that span including covering the L/9 meetings. In those L/9 gms Baylor has outscored KU by an avg of 49-10 and have covered those gms by an avg of 16 pts. Baylor also hasn't all'd KU to score over 14 pts in a gm since 2011. Baylor is off a win against TX Southern while KU dropped to 0-2 after losing 49-22 at Coastal and are 1-14 SU and 3-12 ATS over that span. Baylor's D is an exp'd unit (10 st'rs back) and are holding foes to 258 ypg and 14 ppg & now faces a KU offense that is only avg'g 328 yds & 20 pts per gm. Baylor's offense has been solid (718 yds LW vs FCS TX Southern) under new QB Bohanon but face a KU defense that just all'd CCU to gain 460 yds & put up 49 pts. Baylor won't be in the hunt for the B12 title this season, but they are clearly better than KU under first yr HC Leipold & we think the Bears take the SU/ATS win streak to 10 gms. We went against Baylor LY for our First 5★ and won on W.Virginia!

TOLEDO by 14 over Colorado St - Will be the 4th meeting. Their last mtg came back in 2019 when the Rams hosted Toledo and neither team led by more than 8 pts and the Rockets would go on to win 41-35. UT is off to a 1-1 start and nearly pulled off the upset at Notre Dame last week (ND gm winning TD with 69 sec left 4Q). CSU comes into this game 0-2 on the season & lost last week at home to Vanderbilt on a FG on the last play of the game. CSU had a 305-120 yd edge in the 1H but only led 14-7. Toledo's D gave up 449 yds last week vs ND but did collect 6 sks. CSU's D is giving up 404 ypg & 33 ppg and faces a Toledo offense that is avg'g 229 rush ypg (4.8) and they are hitting 65% of their passes. CSU comes in just 1-5 ATS under HC Addazio & while the Rams have talent, they cant seem to figure it out & we think the Rockets win here by 2 td's.

Northwestern by 6 over DUKE - This series is deadlocked 10-10, with NW having won 8 of the last 11, but Duke having won the previous 2 meetings in '17 and '18. In '18, the Wildcats scored a TD on the opening possesion but were then shutout the remainder of the game in Evanston (-2'), falling 21-7. MSU RB Kenneth Walker III gave NW fits in their wk 1 matchup, going for 264 yds on the ground w/ 4 TDs. The Wildcats will have to be keyed in on another great RB, this time the Blue Devils' Mataeo Durant, who churned out 255 yds on the ground with 3 TDs in a losing effort at Charlotte wk 1 (-6'). FCS NC A&T held Durant to just 41 yds LW (2.7), while NW QB Johnson looks to have a big performance following his impressive wk 1 that followed w/ a subpar performance vs FCS Indiana St. We think the Wildcats pull it out by just under a TD.

ARKANSAS by 16 over Georgia Southern- First meeting. Arkansas is 2-0 after their huge upset win over Texas where the Hogs held a 471-256 yd edge as 6' point dogs. Ark led 16-0 1Q and led 33-7 4Q. TX's last td came in garbage time. GS was blown out last week at FAU 38-6 (+7). They led 7-0 1Q and were outgained 528-257 & out FD'd 27-17. The Eagles have allowed 365 and 332 pass yds in their first 2 games. Ark's strength has been the run, avg 289 (6.4) ypg. GS will likely get QB Justin Tomlin back from suspension. Ark does have a huge game with A&M on deck and considering they just upset Texas they could be in for an emotional letdown. This is only the 2nd time the Hogs have been favored under Pittman, and the first came in wk 1 when they trailed Rice at halftime and scored three 4Q td's to get a front door cover (last td w:58 left). We don't think Arkansas suffers an upset but we could certainly see Georgia Sotuhern keeping it closer than expected.

MEMPHIS by 3 over Mississippi St - The Bulldogs lead the all-time series with Memphis 33-11, having won 12 in a row dating back to '94. However, these teams have not met in a decade and this game should be an absolute shootout. Mississippi St were favored big at home (-20') but trailed La Tech led 34-14 with 12 mins left to go. The Bulldogs charged back from 3 TDs and a FGA with 0:00 for La Tech was no good. Then as HD LW (+1'), Miss St led wire-to-wire in a tightly contested gm from a FD and yd edge persepctive (-19 yds, -1 FDs), and were up 3 TDs w/ a min left before NC St closed the final gap 24-10. The Tigers used big plays to pull out a high-scoring rivarly game on the road w/ Arkansas St where the teams put up 687 yds and 681 yds respectively, 55-50 (-5'). The Bulldogs are a bit of a conundrum but we think the Tigers win by a FG.

WASHINGTON by 20 over Arkansas St - The Huskies and Red Wolves have never met and Ark St is 0-2 all-time against Pac-12 teams. Wash is off to an 0-2 start with losses to FCS Montana & then last wk against Mich in the Big House 31-10. Ark St is 1-1 and lost to Memphis 55-50 and there were 1,360 total yds. Wash was without 4 of their WR's last week & their status is ? as of presstime, but their offense is only avg'g 317 yds and 9 pts. Ark St's offense put up 680 yds last wk and QB's Blackmon (306, 68%, 4-0) and Hatcher (276, 61%, 1-0) split time while 2 WR's went over 100 yds. The Wash offense could get going here against an Ark St D that allowed 680 yds (417 pass/263 rush) last week. Ark St did go 3-0 ATS LY against non-conf foes incl pulling the outright upset against KSt, while Wash is just 1-5 ATS overall under HC Lake. While the Huskies have not started off the way we thought, we think they rebound here with a win by nearly 3 td's.

LIBERTY by 30 over Old Dominion- Liberty won last meeting in '18 52-10 and finished with a 593-301 yd edge. The Flames pulled out a 21-13 (-4') road win at Troy last week. Liberty finished w/339-232 yd & 22-14 FD edges. ODU got their first win since 2019 last week, beating local rival Hampton 47-7 (-20). The Monarchs last 3 wins have come against FCS foes and their last FBS win was back in '18. They've lost their last 13 vs FBS foes and only 3 of those were by single-digits. Liberty is 5-1 as 20+ point chalk under HC Freeze. The Monarchs did add some Power-5 transfers before the season started and Liberty has Syracuse on deck but ODU lost by 31 in the opener at Wake Forest and we think this will be a similar result.

MARSHALL by 6 over East Carolina - ECU leads the all-time series against Marshall 10-5, with The Herd claiming the most recent victory back in '13. Marshall is averaging 47.5 ppg and had a surprising 49-7 romp at Navy in their opener (-3'). They followed that up by putting away a tough FCS NC Central by 34 pts. However, the Thundering Herd are just 5-9 ATS vs non-conf tms the L3Y. While The Pirates did not look as sharp in their opener as they would've wanted (missed first PAT of ssn), falling in Charlotte to App St 33-19 (+9), playing SEC foe South Carolina was a different story. ECU led 17-14 on the road in the 4Q before losing on a GW FG with 0:00. We expect Marshall to win by just under a TD. In 2017 we won our September 5★ on Marshall but this time could we go against the Thundering Herd?

LT is 4-1 SU/ATS in this series, including a 51-10 win over the Mustangs in the 2017 Frisco Bowl as LT is 4-1 SU/AIS in this series, including a 51-10 win over tine musiangs in the 2017 FISCO DOWN as 5 point dogs. SMU trailed 9-7 at half vs another CUSA foe last week, in NTexas. QB Mordecai threw 2 int's and SMU fumbled at the NT3 in a surprisingly low scoring 1st half. Mordecai threw 3 td's in the 2H and SMU won 35-12 (-22'). LT nearly upset Miss St in their opener then had a letdown last week and was nearly upset by Southeastern, only winning 45-42 (-11'). The Bulldogs never trailed but were outgained 598-448 and were torched by former Arkanas QB Cole Kelley for 495 yds. Now the Bulldogs face former Oklahoma QB Mordecai who has thrown for 11 td's in 2 games. LT also has a former Oklahoma QB in Austin Kendall but he's only got a 3-2 ratio. HC Holtz is much better as a road dog than at home (3-5 HD, 16-8-1 as AD but SMU is only 3-7 as an AF and we think the Mustanas win by iust under a touchdown.

Troy by 4 over SOUTHERN MISS - Teams have met 10 times with SMiss holding a 8-2 edge. Last meeting came back in '19 when Troy hosted SMiss and lost 47-42 in a game where there was over 1000 passing yds! Troy is off a home loss against Liberty 21-13 where they only put up 232 yds incl just 21 rush yds. SMiss rebounded last week with a 37-0 win vs FCS Grambling, giving us another 3★ winner in our Small College plays (4-0 on the year!). SMiss did lose QB Lowe to inj (CS). The SMiss D has played well this season as they have all'd just 221 ypg and their run D has been superb as they have given up just 41 ypg (1.3). Troy's D has played well too this season, only all'g 264 ypg and they held Liberty & QB Willis to 339 yds & 21 pts. Troy does have transfer QB Powell under center & he is hitting 66% and faces a SMiss pass D that gave up 269 yds (77%) to SAIa 2 wks ago. SMiss also has allowed 7 sks in 2 gms & Troy had 5 sks last wk. SMiss however is 6-0 ATS as a HD since 2015 & we think they keep this gm within a TD.

TEXAS TECH by 17 over Fiu - Only met once before back in '05 when TTU hosted FIU and they won 56-3 with a 653-349 yd edge. TTU started the season 2-0 but only beat FCS SF Austin by 6 pts as they all'd 343 pass yds. While the pass D wasn't great, the TTU run D is all'g just 55 ypg (1.7). That TTU D will face an FIU offense putting up 497 yds (gms vs Long Island & TXSt) and they have thrown for 268 ypg. Most impressively FIU has all'd just 1 sk in 53 pass att but TTU has collected 6 sks in 2 gms. FIU is off a home lost to TXSt in OT despite being +64 in yds (-3 TO's).TTU was 0-2 LY as 20+ point chalk and with the Red Raiders having their B12 opener on deck against Texas so if

they get up big in the 2H they could rest some st'rs and there could be back door potential.

Utah by 3 over SAN DIEGO ST - Former MW foes have met 30 times with Utah holding a 17-12-1 lead all-time. The last meeting came back in 2010 when Utah (-2') won 38-34 on the road. Utah is off their rivalry game last week against BYU where they lost 26-17 while SDSt faced another Pac-12 team in Arizona last week on the road & pulled the outright upset 38-14 (454-228). Utah's offense comes in avg'g 191 rush ypg (6.8) but they face a SDSt run D that is all'g just 49 ypg (2.2) and the Aztecs have collected 9 sks in 2 gms. On the flip side SDSt is a team that relies on a strong rush attack & they are avg'g 260 ypg (5.4) led by RB G. Bell (286,7.5) and Utah just all'd BYU to rush for 219 (4.8) last wk. SDSt is 4-1 ATS since 2015 as a home underdog & Utah is just 2-5 ATS off of BYU. GEORGIA by 35 over South Carolina- UGA has won 5 of the last 6 meetings (4-2 ATS). The home team is 1-4 SU/0-5 ATS and the Over has hit in 6 of the last 8. UGA was without QB JT Daniels last week (inj. Check status) but apparently that didn't matter. Stetson Bennett came in and hit 10 passes for 288 yards and 5 td's as the Dawgs embarrassed UAB 56-7 (-24). SCar opened as the underdog last week but quickly flipped to the favorite at East Carolina. The Gamecocks trailed 14-0 2Q and barely avoided the upset loss, getting a GW fg as time ran out. SC finished with 320-268 yd & 15-11 FD edges. Now SC has to take on one of the top D's in the country that limited Clemson & UAB to a comb'd 10 points and 177 ypg. Last year UGA ran for 332 (7.2) so they should be fine even if Daniels doesn't play and it's hard to imagine Zeb Noland having any success against this Dawgs defense. It's hard to imagine playing against UGA right now so we've got the Dawgs by 5 td's.

PENN ST by 11 over Auburn- ESPN College Gameday will be on hand for this non-conference matchup. Both teams come in 2-0 but Penn St has the 2 best wins, beating Wisc on the road and LY's MAC champions Ball St 41-13 (-22') last week while Auburn is untested after beating Akron and Alabama St by a combined 122-10. Will see if Auburn QB Bo Nix' road struggles continue under Bryan Harsin. Nix has a 12-2 record with a 20-1 ratio at home but just 5-7 with a 12-12 ratio on the road. Penn St's defense has 7 starters back from last year and the Nittany Lions are on a 6-0 SU/ ATS run going back to last year. Auburn is 8-17 as an AD and Penn St is 31-10-1 ATS when coming off a win. Auburn has to deal with a night game in whiteout conditions with a QB who struggles on the road so naturally we have a strong lean with the Nittany Lions.

AIR FORCE by 12 over Utah St - All-time AF is 5-3 against USU with all but 1 meeting coming as MW foes & AF has won 5 of the L/6 mtgs SU. AF is off a 23-3 win against their rival Navy where they held them to 68 total yards! USU is off to a 2-0 start this ssn after a 48-24 win vs N.Dakota last wk. USU is already showing sligns of improvement under 1st yr HC Anderson as QB Bonner is hitting 67% while they are avg g 220 rush ypg (5.2) & the D is allowing 400 ypg & 24 ppg. Anderson also has seen the option before at Ark St when facing GSthrn. AF HC Calhoun was underselling his tm in the offssn, but they have 9 st'rs back on D and they have collected 8 sks in 2 gms. Despite AF having a new OL the Falcons are rushing for 273 ypg. The Falcons are 5-0-1 ATS against USU in the L/6 gms & more recently AF outscored USU 66-14 the L2Y, & ran for a comb'd 782 yds. While the Aggies are improved, we still like AF & their strong D and rush attack to propel them to a DD win.

NORTH CAROLINA by 14 over Virginia- NCar has lost 4 straight vs UVA including last year as 7 point chalk, 44-41 but they did have a 536-418 yd edge. The Heels lost as 1' pt chalk in '19 38-31 where they also had a slight yds edge. Last week we pointed out that the Heels won all 3 games last year when coming off a loss by 27, 32 & 40 so felt the Heels would dominate Georgia St and that's exactly what they did, winning 59-17 (-26). The Heels held a 607-271 yd edge and QB Howell threw for 353 yds and 3 td's, adding 104 rush as well. UVA racked up their 18th home win since 2018 last week, beating Illinois 42-14 (-10'). QB Armstrong threw for 405 and 5 td's and UVA had 556-337 yd & 31-20 FD edges. The Cavaliers only led 21-14 3Q before pulling away. UVA has covered 7 straight road openers but NCar is on a 6-1 run as a HF and still angry after losing their ACC opener so we've got the Heels by 2 td's.

LSU by 17 over Central Michigan - First meeting but CM HC McElwain went 2-1 vs LSU when HC at Florida. Both teams come in 1-1 SU but LSU is 0-2 ATS while CM is 2-0 ATS. Both teams are off wins over FCS foes but while LSU failed to cover as a 39 pt HF winning 34-7, CM covered as a 37 pt HF winning 45-0. As you would expect LSU has the Offensive (#20-#60) & Defensive (#37-#80) edges but not by as mush as you would expect between SEC & MAC foes. Chippewas are 6-6 ATS as a non-conf DD AD including 2 outright wins & covered vs SEC foe Missouri in their opener as a 14 pt AD, never trailing by more than 10. Despite losing 34-24 CM actually had a slight yardage & FD edge but were -2 TO's. LSU also has their SEC opener on deck which could see their starters sitting if they get up in the 2H giving CM an even better chance to cover.

Uab by 17 over NORTH TEXAS - UAB has won the L/2 mtgs and is 4-0 ATS. They didn't meet LY and LTH the Blazers pulled out a 26-21 (-3) win. Apologies to Late Phone subscribers for last week's UAB shellacking. UGA was missing their QB and UAB has a veteran squad with a quality HC but obviously the Blazers were no match after their 56-7 loss. NT led SMU 6-0 2Q last week and finished with a 23-20 FD edge but the Mustangs pulled away in the 2H and lost by 23 for a half-point non-cover. The Mean Green put up 506 yards but only 12 points, getting SOD 4 times with 2 int's. HC Clark is 9-4-1 ATS off a SU loss and the Blazers will be fired up for their CUSA opener. We can't help but go with UAB who has a HUGE edge on D and will be furious after last week's embarrassing performance.

TEXAS by 21 over Rice - Former Southwest Conf foes have played 95 times with Texas holding a 73-21-1 edge in the series. After an impressive opening win vs LA the Longhorns were thrashed last View line series. After all impressive opening with SEA the Eding from the magnetic flat week in Arkansas as they fell 40-21 (256-471) as they gave up 333 rush yds (7.1). Tex QB Card went just 8-15 passing for 61 yds and the Tex OL has all'd 6 sks in 2 gms. Both teams played Arkansas this ssn and unlike Texas, the Owls actually led Ark 17-7 in the 3O but lost 38-17. Last week Rice lost 44-7 as they were -3 TO's incl a pick-six. Rice is only avg'g 260 yds and 12 pits on offense, but their Dis Judges 6 led or a giving up 32 yars 8 being 5 led in 2 gms. Tays has their 812 openser. their D is playing solid and are giving up 383 ypg & have 5 sks in 2 gms. Texas has their B12 opener on deck and the Owls are 8-3 ATS the L3Y as a 20+ pt underdog.

MISSISSIPPI by 17 over Tulane - Ole Miss leads the all-time series 41-28 but have won 9 in a row dating back to '89. Matt Corral is a Heisman candidate who has been impressive early (662, 66%, 6/0 in 2 gms), and has shown alot of toughness while leading his Rebels to 2-0 start both SU and ATS. With the stage all to himself on Labor Day, he led Ole Miss to a 43-24 victory over Louisville in Atlanta, throwing for 381 yds while the offense outgained the Cardinals by an edge of +214. Tulane is also 2-0 ATS to start the yr after an improbable, near come-from-behind win against Oklahoma. A "home" game for the Green Wave in Norman after being dislplaced by Hurricane Ida was a truly inspirational effort for a tm that OU QB Rattler described as the hardest hitting he has ever faced We believe Tulane comes back down to earth and falls by over 2 td's.

BOISE ST by 7 over Oklahoma St - In '18 OSU (-1) won 44-21 despite only being +8 in yds and -4 in FD's. Boise would have 2 punts blk'd that OSU turned into 14 pts. Boise is off a home game last Fri against UTEP where they beat UTEP 54-13 despite only being +125 yds. Boise had a PR TD & scored 2 TD's off TO's. OSÚ got back QB Sanders last week, but had inj's to several other players & hung on to beat Tulsa 28-23. Through 2 gms Boise QB Bachmeier has thrown for 603 yds (67%, 4-1) & his favorite target is WR Shakir (257, 21.4). Boise RB Holani did come back too which is a big boost for the offense. OSU is only putting up 341 ypg/26 ppg on offense but their D has been solid, allowing 342 ypg/20 ppg & they have 7 sks in 2 gms. However OSU's pass D has all'd 229 ypg & this Boise pass attack is the best they have faced so far. Boise comes in 8-2 ATS as a HF the L3Y & we like the Broncos to win on the blue turf, especially given the inj conerns for OSU.

Arizona St by 3 over BYU - This marks the 1st test in '21 for the Sun Devils after getting easy 27 pt victories over both Southern Utah and UNLV the past 2 weeks. The Cougars on the other hand are playing their 3rd consecutive matchup inside of the P12 with a win over Arizona and a 9 pt victory against rival Utah (led 23-7 after 3Q's, 380-340 yd edge) in the "Holy War". ASU has actually won 20 of the past 25 meetings against BYU coming in although they have dropped 3 of the L/4 when visiting Provo including last time here in '98 (Sun Devils fell 26-6 as a 6' pt favorite). With ASU going a perfect 3-0 ATS away from home LY and BYU having failed to cover 5 of their L/8 as a HD, we'll go ahead and give the visitor a small lean in this one.

lowa St by 31 over UNLV - Teams have met 5 previous times and ISU holds a 4-1 record. However in their last meeting back in '08 in Las Vegas the Rebels (-2) won 34-31 in OT. ISU lost to rival lowa last wk 27-17 (3★ LP winner on the UNDER!) despite being +166 in yds (-4 TO's). UNLV is off to an 0-2 start after losing last week at Ariz St. UNLV's offense has struggled to find a QB & their best player is RB Williams who has ran for 207 (5.2) this ssn, but they face an ISU D that has all'd just 224 ypg/19 ppg this ssn. UNLV's OL has also 9 sks in 2 gms. UNLV's D has all'd 467 ypg incl 275 pass ypg and they face one of the better college QB's in Brock Purdy. ISU also has one of the top RB's in the country with Breece Hall & UNLV all'd 287 rush yds (6.1) last wk. ISU is just 1-5 ATS the L3Y as a 20+ point favorite & they have their B12 opener next week and may pull strs in the 2H, however UNLV is just 2-7 ATS under HC Arroyo & just dont have the talent to keep up with a Top 15 team.

UCLA by 8 over Fresno St - Teams have met 9 times with UCLA holding a 6-3 edge. However Fresno has won the L/3 mtgs including a 38-14 win back in '18 in the Rose Bowl. Overall Fresno has covered 4 of the L/5 meetings in this series. UCLA gets this game off a bye & are off to a 2-0 start including a home upset of #16 LSU. The Bruins offense has avg'd 431 ypg & 41 ppg incl 227 rush yds (5.0) but they have all'd 6 sks this season & they face a FSt D that has 10 sks in 3 gms. Overall FSt's D has all'd 246 ypg & at Oregon 2 wks ago they only all'd 358 yds. UCLA's D has held foes to 324 ypg incl just 38 rush ypg (1.6) but they have all'd 287 pass ypg & face a Fresno offense led by QB Haener who has thrown for 1009 (74%, 4-0). Fresno has gone 2-1 ATS under HC DeBoer as an underdog and UCLA is just 3-7 ATS as a HF under HC Kelly, though they did beat Hawaii from the MW 44-10 earlier this ssn. However we feel like Fresno is a better MW team and with QB Haener

and a solid defense we feel the Bulldogs will keep this game within single digits.

San Jose St by 9 over HAWAII - LY SJSt broke their 4 gm losing streak to UH when they went to the islands and won 35-24. The past 3 mtgs have all been decided by 9 pts or less. SJSt is off a bye week & 2 wks ago they only trailed USC 13-7 in 4Q but fell 30-7. UH is off a loss at Oregon St 45-27. SJSt is led by veteran QB Starkel and the Spartans are still putting up 359 pass ypg & they face a Hawaii pass defense that gave up 400 yds to FCS Portland St 2 wks ago & SJSt has also all'd 0 sks in 76 pass att. UH's offense is avg'g 421 ypg and 30 ppg & are led by QB Cordeiro & RB/WR Calvin Turner, but their OL has all'd 9 sks in 3 gms & they face a SJSt D that has all'd 333 ypg and 22 ppg & has the reigning MW DPOY Cade Hall (10 sks LY). UH can score, but their D has had issues (476 ypg/41 ppg) & UH is 2-4 ATS in their L/6 MW home openers. SJSt is 6-2 ATS in their MW road openers & UH will not have any fans for this game due to covid restrictions in Hawaii.

The Bills meanwhile suffered a surprising home loss to Beach for their 2nd consec DIV matchup. The bills meanwrite surietieu a surprising nome loss to the Steelers (led 10-0 at HT) despite 22-16 FD & 371-252 yd edges (PIT blik'd punt for TD). The Bills have dominated their recent matchups against AFC East rival MIA with wins in 7 of the last 8 (5-2-1 ATS) including a 2-game series sweep in each of the past 2 years. The Giants have owned the recent history against their DIV rival with 5 consecutive SU wins (4-1 ATS) including a 23-20 victory in D.C. a year ago. They are however just 3-7-1 ATS in road openers while WAS is on a 6-2 overall ATS run coming in (QB Fitzpatrick? winj as of presstime). We'll have one of

New Orleans by 7 over CAROLINA - After picking up a 5 pt home win against the Jets LW (led 16-0 at HT) where we cashed a Top Play 3.5★ LP Winner, the Panthers are back at home for a 2nd straight wk to take on a Saints squad that's failed to cover 9 of their L/11 "true" road openers. While NO was expected to kickoff the '21 campaign inside of the Superdome against GB, Hurricane Ida's aftermath saw LW's matchup played in JAX. Despite the change in venue, the Saints (+3') demolished GB by a 38-3 score with QB Jameis Winston throwing for 5 TD's! Since the '17 season, the Saints have knocked off the Panthers in 8 of 9 matchups including a 33-7 win LY in Charlotte thanks in part to +5 TO's (21 pt avg road MOV in that span). With CAR failing to cover 7 straight DIV HG's coming in and NO on an 8-1-1 ATS run overall, the visitor gets the TD lean in this one. CLEVELAND by 7 over Houston - Following a tough trip to Arrowhead LW to begin the '21 season (led 22-10 at HT in eventual 5 pt loss), the Browns return home to take on a Texans squad that picked up a commanding 37-21 win over the Jags with former Browns QB Tyrod Taylor finishing with 291 pass yds & 2 TD's. LY the Browns ended a 5-game losing skid against the Texans with a 10-7 victory in nasty weather (356-243 yd edge). While CLE is clearly the stronger team in this matchup, they've been a DD favorite on just 1 occasion over the past 13 years! With HOU an impressive 10-5 ATS as a NDIV AD, we'll call for them to stay within the line here.

CHICAGO by 7 over Cincinnati - The Bears return to Soldier Field following a rough trip out to LA on SNF where the Rams picked up a 20 pt victory. The Bengals meanwhile collected a 27-24 OT win against the Vikings in the return of QB Joe Burrow (261 pass yds, 2 TD's). The Bears have knocked off the Bengals in each of their L/2 meetings including an easy 33-7 victory back in '17 when they were actually a 6' pt dog (CHI 29-14 FD & 482-234 yd edges). While they have failed to cover 4 straight when listed as a NDIV HF, QB Andy Dalton is clearly looking for revenge against his former squad that he spent the first 9 years in the league with. It's also worth mentioning that

the Bengals have gone just 8-13 ATS in recent matchups with the NFC.

PITTSBURGH by 3 over Las Vegas - It's been 49 years since the Raiders suffered a heartbreaking playoff loss to the Steelers in one of the most famous plays in football history (The Immaculate Reception). Despite being a perennial playoff squad in recent years, the Steelers have actually struggled against the Raiders with 3 losses over their past 4 contests including a 24-21 loss in '18 inside of the "Black Hole". PIT returns to Heinz Field following a surprising Wk 1 road trip to BUF where they overcame a 10-0 HT defict in a 23-16 victory (+6'). While the Raiders do head into this meeting on short rest after their MNF contest at home against the Ravens, they have gone an impressive 7-1 ATS in road openers.

La Rams by 1 over INDIANAPOLIS - The Rams and Colts have had some one-sided affairs over

their past 5 matchups with a 29 pt avg MOV (LAR won L/2). IND is at home for a 2nd consecutive week after a 12 pt loss to the Seahawks (Carson Wentz 251 pass yds & 2-0 ratio). The Rams meanwhile are heading to IND following a SNF meeting against the Bears where Matt Stafford meanwhile are reading to IND following a SNY friedling against the Beats where war, standing threw for 321 yds & 3 TD's in his debut. Although the Rams have had some solid success in recent trips East including a Wk 2 trip to PHI LY (37-19 win, +1'), keep in mind that the Colts are 10-3-1 ATS against NFC foes and 10-4 ATS as a NDIV HD!

The Jets meanwhile suffered a 19-14 defeat LW in Charlotte (3.5★ LP Winner on the Panthers!) in the debut of rookie QB Zach Wilson who struggled mightily in the 1H before finding more consistency in the 2H (258 pass yds, 2-1 ratio).
