The Post Draft Issue grades a team's offseason a little differently than most. The grades we put into Power Sweep predict whether a team's record will improve or decline for the upcoming season. We take EVERYTHING into account. Included in the analysis are coaching changes, the NFL Draft, Free Agent signings, Free Agent losses and even favorable or unfavorable schedules. The "A" & "D" grades have been extremely accurate over the years. We spend a great deal of time and effort making these grades and while there was no list in '11 (work stoppage), here is a recap of the past 28 years as well as the record from the last 13 years with grades ('09, '10 & '12-'21).

Overview: While the Bills have strung together a 47-18 record the past 4 years, they've left the postseason a bit disappointed with the Chiefs and Bengals finding some success against them. This year the team appears to be just as solid with the defense seeing some solid FA additions in LB Leonard Floyd and DB Taylor Rapp. The early schedule could potentially see BUF jump out to an 8-0 start as home games against MIA & NYG are the only playoff teams from a year ago that they take on in that span. With the #2 scoring offense and defense in '23, we have no issue calling for the Bills to cash in on the AFC East once again. The bigger question however will be if they can FINALLY get past the other AFC blue bloods and reach their first Super Bowl since 1993.

Overview: The Patriots suffered a losing campaign for the 2nd time in 3 years a season ago in a year of dysfunction with QB Mac Jones having issues with the offensive coaching duo of Matt Patricia and Joe Judge. New OC Bill O'Brien could be just what the doctor ordered this year in Foxboro with some solid FA additions and a heavy offensive emphasis in the latter part of the 2023 Draft that Bill Belichick and company usually thrive in developing. The early part of their schedule looks daunting with 3 playoff teams from a year ago in the first 4 weeks while they have matchups against the Chiefs and Bills in December. With the expected rise from the Jets and both BUF and MIA making the postseason a year ago, the Patriots could find themselves in the AFC East basement for the first time since 2000.

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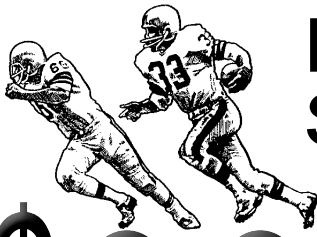
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
